Corey Callahan gets an A minus on the HRU report card

Corey Callahan - A

"Little Corey has been a joy to teach this semester at harness racing school. He has given media interviews that are wise beyond his years. He has shown up to track each day, sometimes doing extra credit by working at two tracks. He is on pace to score over 700 wins and \$8 million dollars in earnings at school this year. He has developed into a very good harness driver and is a welcoming face for the sport. Well

"The Meadowlands has put forth a marvelous effort so far in 2013. They have carded some interesting betting affairs, have cleaned up the entry box, and have tried new things something in harness racing school that is not done very often. They have tried to limit their spending scope, while not hurting the end product or on-track product too much. They are also lobbying - probably successfully - for a casino, which if completed could vault their score next semester. They recently let a trainer out of detention, who then received a positive test for soda, which looked premature. As well,

"Unheralded in many previous semesters, this trainer has taken harness racing school by storm. All of his trotters look like happy little clams on the racetrack and one of his stars - Maven - just set a track record at Woodbine. This 'morning sickness' did not go over well late in the year with many pacers going slower than their April and May morning sessions. Ron Pierce - Incomplete

"In the first semester we have not seen little Ronnie as much as we're used to. He has missed some days, probably fishing or hunting somewhere. We only have three or four interviews to grade him on, so he has gotten an incomplete mark. In the second semester we will see more of Ronnie and our usual interview scoring system will be grading him appropriately. Ronnie is working well with others. NEWARK AIRPORT—The plane leaves shortly for Stockholm and 7 hours and 55 minutes later I will arrive in Sweden. Everyone—and I mean everyone—who has been to the Elitlopp says it is the experience of a lifetime and I've always wanted to soak it up. My only regret is that I picked a year in which the North American contingent is not especially strong. Arch Madness is a warrior, but he is 9 and is winless in three starts this year. It has a purse of roughly \$900,000, is contested at the onemile distance and is supposed to be a phenomenally cool event, so it strikes me as strange that more American stables don't target this race. The drought for the North American horses now goes back 15 years, to when Moni Maker won in 1998.

The best tip I have gotten prior to leaving came from a colleague, who said don't count on drinking too much, that you'll go broke because alcohol is so expensive in Sweden. Or just find someone else to pay for it. So noted.



Sirius XM's Saturday Night at the Races to Debut With June 1 Rooney

Saturday Night at the Races, which features live radio broadcasts of many of the top harness races in North America, will begin its fourth year June 1 with a show



featuring the Art Rooney Pace and the Lismore at Yonkers. The June 1 show will air on Sirius

XM radio from 9 to 11 pm. All Saturday Night at the Races broadcasts can be heard on Sirius Channel 93 and XM Channel 209.

This year's slate will consist of 10 shows which will include coverage of the Hambletonian, the North America Cup, the Meadowlands Pace, the Little Brown Jug and the Breeders Crown.

Dave Johnson and Bill Finley will serve as the hosts of the show and trainer and owner Peter Kleinhans will again handle the role of analyst.

The shows are possible thanks to the generosity of its sponsors, the USTA, the Hambletonian Society, Yonkers Raceway, the Meadowlands, Tioga Downs, Vernon Downs and the Pennsylvania Harness Horsemen's Association.

Toscano Stable Poised For Big Weekend

Linda Toscano has waited a bit longer than most trainers to unleash her big guns, but this weekend it will be time to get down to business. Toscano's Dan Patch Award winner Heston Blue Chip (American Ideal) headlines a \$25,000 Open Saturday at the Meadowlands and her New York Sire Stakes champ Doctor Butch (Art Major) looks like the one to beat in the elims for the Art Rooney at Yonkers.

Tim Tetrick will begin his night at Yonkers driving Doctor Butch before driving over the George Washington Bridge to pilot Heston Blue Chip at the Meadowlands.

Heston Blue Chip, one of three Dan Patch Award winners Toscano campaigned last year, will be making his first pari-mutuel start since last year when he capped off a \$1 million season with a win in the Matron Stakes at Dover. He's had two qualifiers this year and is, Toscano, said, ready to go. The five-horse field also includes his stablemate, Bettor's Edge (Bettor's Delight).

"It's tough being a 4-year-old," she said. "He's turned out great, so has Bettor's Edge. The two horses are bigger and stronger than they were last year, but it is hard to take on the older horses. This is a starting point and they'll tell us. As a group, the owners,

decided to take things one race at a time with these horses. Heston Blue Chip is eligible to everything here on in. The following week there is the Free-For-All series at the Meadowlands and then the Roll With Joe and that's as far ahead as we have planned.

"You have to manage them at 4; you have to understand they are going against heavy duty campaigners that have done it before, really seasoned performers. You have to hope you don't break their hearts and that they will turn into next year's more seasoned campaigners. Heston Blue Chip is a beautiful horse to race, and the same goes for Bettor's Edge. They have gait speed, can race on any racetrack, don't wear boots, so the bottom line is I can take them to any track and get them seasoned and their get sea legs under them without abusing them."

The competition is far from stiff in the Meadowlands race, but Toscano said she's fine with that.

"It is never too easy in the beginning," she said. "It's about building that foundation. I am a big believer that if you build a foundation the building doesn't tumble."

Doctor Butch was supplemented into the Rooney at a cost of \$30,000 and is only in that race because the New York Sire Stakes season has been delayed due to the outbreak of the Equine Herpes Virus at Vernon Downs.

"We had sire stakes races at Vernon that we were going to bring him along in," she said. "We had him ready and this happened and we needed a race. \$30,000 is a big number, but this looked like the best opportunity for us under the circumstances."

Toscano admits she was disappointed by Doctor Butch's last qualifier, when he was second at the Meadowlands in 1:51.4, but says she knows now what went wrong.

"I was disappointed, but that's who I am," she said. "I know

how he was prepared, how good he was in his last qualifier. But the problem was quickly resolved. The pollen count was high and he had some guttural pouches. There was a little bit of an allergic component there. It wasn't a big deal."

In the second Rooney elimination Toscano will send out Swift As A Shadow (Bettor's Delight), who is coming off a fourth-place finish in a C-1 at the Meadowlands. Toscano believes the colt will do better on the half-mile track.

"He's a tiny little guy who is built for that racetrack at Yonkers," she said.

Winning Mister Honored as PA "Horse of the Year"

The "Best of 2012" awards were handed out last night by the Keystone Chapter of the U.S. Harness Writers'

Association, and leading the way as Pennsylvania's "Horse of the Year" was Bob Key's Winning Mister 1:51.3 (\$1,108,874), the millionaire and FFA trotting star who established track records at every Pennsylvania harness track--and six

track records in all.

Last year alone, Winning Mister, also bred by Key and trained by Rich Gillock, took 13 victories at Pennsylvania tracks in open, preferred, and FFA competition, and earned more than \$318,000 in that racing season.

A stakes winner at both two and three, he won 24 open and FFA events from ages four through six and won 32 times in 1:55 or faster, 11 times in 1:53 or less.

"The horse's raw speed is what I think sets him apart from the rest," said Key. "And what's so important to racing in Pennsylvania, he had tremendous ability to get around the turns on the five-eighths mile tracks very handily, and carry his high speed throughout the mile."

The son of Angus Hall is from the American Winner mare Winning Missbrenda, making him a three-quarter brother to Key's World Champion filly Win Missy B 3,1:52 (\$1.568,286).

Winning Mister now stands his first season at stud at Lindwood Farm in Pennsylvania at a fee of \$4,500, \$4,000 for multiple mares.

Maharajah Out of Elitlopp

Maharajah, considered one of the top Swedish hopes in Sunday's Elitlopp in Stockholm, has been scratched from the race due to a minor leg injury.

Trained by Stefan Hutlman, he is owned by Travkompaniet, which has 4,500 shareholders. The same stable will still be represented by longshot Panne De Motuer.

Seabstin K., also from Sweden, is the solid favorite with *(continued on next page)*

most bookmakers. He is currently at 8-5 with William Hill. The price on Arch Madness at William Hill is 16-1 and Take My Picture is 50-1.

Vernon Downs Racing Schedule Revised

There are a number of schedule changes for racing at Vernon Downs as a result of the recent quarantine, which is to be lifted on Saturday, June 1.

Horses that are not stabled at Vernon may enter to race for



the June 1 card and from there forward. Qualifiers for that week will be held on Saturday, June 1 as well to accommodate trainers with horses that need to be qualified that are stabled off the grounds.

The Empire Breeders Classic (EBC) trotting eliminations have been moved from Friday, May 31

and will be raced on Sunday, June 2 with a post time of 1:15pm.

The live racing program originally scheduled for Wednesday, June 5 has been canceled. Sunday, June 9 (post time 6:45) will be added in its place. The EBC trotting finals and Excelsior series events for three year old colt and filly trotters will be raced on that card.

Race Secretary Scott Warren will conduct a double draw on Wednesday, May 29 for the June 1 & 2 cards and again on Wednesday, June 5 for the June 8 & 9 race cards.

Further, live racing is canceled for Saturday, June 15 due to a concert. That card will be raced on Sunday, June 16 at 1:15pm.

Please be advised that all details herein are contingent upon no further complications with the quarantine.

Race 7, F&M B-2/B-1/A-2 Pace

This exact filly and mare handicap is becoming a weekly edition in these pages, and this week MARTY PARTY is Dave Miller's pick of almost half the field. This one lands a much improved post while making her second start back

over the track; has a great deal of class. BULLET POINT is one that I've liked in both her starts here and from this spot she still could be overlooked. Had late pace once free in her last. BROKENART HANOVER made an ill-fated try for the lead last out but now picks up Pierce. Her try two back was good. MAJOR LOOK is an obvious short priced contender from the rail still searching for her first win of the year; was done in by the fast pace last week.

Race 8, C-2 Trot

SOUTHWIND CORNELL set the pace in his qualifier and weakened late to finish just a few lengths behind last years Hambo winner, Market Share. Gelding by Majestic Son makes his first start for Julie Miller; I could see a good effort coming. SHALOM G showed speed last out and just missed in a 1:54 mile; anything resembling that would make him difficult as Tetrick's choice. DOUBLE UP HANOVER disappointed last out and is now rewarded with post 10; won't be easy. MARCUS BI faced some decent rivals in his last pair; Smith capable of bringing an occasional longshot trotter home.

Race 9, F&M C-2/C-1 Pace

LIGHTNING PAIGE has been very good in her last couple starts here since the move to Elliott and exits a lifetime best mile. The winner of her race two back already repeated next out; she's the one to beat in her current form. SOMSTREETSOMWHERE tackles older and 3-year-olds racing in these conditions haven't fared particularly well. Tough call either way. DE VINS GIRL jumps up with a good try in spots like this every now and then; MISS SAND CREEK drops.

Race 10, C-2 Trot

FOUNTAINBLEAU VOLO has been terrible this year but I find myself tempted to back him in this spot, even with Dauplaise aboard. His mile last week wasn't terrible and all of his recent rivals are superior to those. AEQUITAS loomed from post 10 last out and is the likely short priced favorite on the move inside; I believe he has won here in the past. REGION HALL invades from Saratoga and goes from Pantano to Pierce; that should be worth a few seconds. MISS CONNOR will be blasting.
