**2013: The Year of the 4-Year-Old**

Thinking Out Loud (Ponder) and Bolt The Duer (Ponder) finished one-two in last week's U.S. Pacing Championship, a pair of 4-year-olds sweeping the cold exacta against a group of tough older veterans. Then again, no one should have

been that surprised. In a sport that has held firm to the belief that 4-year-olds are at a distinct disadvantage against even older horses 4-year-olds have had a banner year on the racetrack.

There have been 21 races worth \$100,000 or more and open to 4-year-olds and up contested so far this year in North America and 10 of them, more than half, have been won by 4-year-olds. In the William Haughton, 4-year-olds finished

1-2-3-4.

The list doesn't include 4-year-old Warrawee Needy's record win in the U.S. Pacing Championship elims, where he went 1:46.4, tying the record for the fastest ever mile in a race.

Are 4-year-olds really up against it or is that a myth that has been exposed this year? It's hard to argue for the former, against the latter.

In the thoroughbred game, no one has ever suggested that a 4-year-old is at a disadvantage against 5, 6, 7 year-olds. Rather, a 3-year-old has to go against the older horses starting in the fall when 3-year-old only races disappear from the schedule. They do get a break in the weights against older horses, but only a slight one. In harness racing the fear of younger facing older runs so deep that a 3-year-old going against older is virtually unheard of.

Are the breeds that different or is harness racing wedded to a concept that just isn't true?

It may be that the success of 4-year-olds this year is an outlier, but if that's the case there is an obvious reason for that. Before Jeff Gural created new rules that all but prevented 3-year-olds from being retired early for breeding duty the very best 3-year-olds never made it past their sophomore seasons. What would Somebeachsomewhere, Muscle Hill, Rock N Roll Heaven, Donato Hanover et. al have done in their 4-year-old seasons if they had had 4-year-old seasons?

With most big stars retiring after their 3-year-old years the only 4-year-olds left were either geldings or ones that were a cut below the very best. It's likely that their struggles contributed to the notion that you had to be 5 or older to do well in the free-for-all ranks.

This year, virtually every top 3-year-old from 2012 is racing, and winning. If the year were to end today the older male pacing championship (Pet Rock or Bolt The Duer), the older mare trotting championship (Maven) and the older male trotting championship (Market Share) would all go to 4-year-olds.

Perhaps the only drawback to racing 4-year-olds is the limited opportunities. The sport remains top heavy when it comes to 2 and, especially 3-year-old races. Market Share, a Hambletonian winner, is exactly the type of horse that Jeff Gural wanted to keep around. He is out there performing this year, but there's not another suitable stakes race on the schedule for him until the Sept. 6 Credit Winner at Vernon Downs. It's even worse for trotting mares, where the opportunities are few and far between.

In the meantime, the 4-year-olds march on. Next up for them will be the 8-17 Joe Gerrity Final at Saratoga Harness and it's hard to imagine anyone beating Pet Rock, Bolt The Duer, Sweet Lou, Warrawee Needy, Thinking Out Loud.

Pity the poor 5 and ups

## Jamieson Joins \$100-million Club

**CAMPBELLVILLE**, August 9 - Driver Jody Jamieson surpassed the coveted career earnings milestone of \$100-million with a victory aboard Panpero Firpo in an \$18,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots division for three-year-old pacing colts and geldings Friday evening at Mohawk Racetrack.

Jamieson and Panpero Firpo found the wire first in 1:51.1 for trainer David Menary. The momentous occasion came in race two on the program.

Jamieson, a three-time O'Brien Award winner as Canada's Driver of the Year, was honoured to surpass the milestone.

"A 36-year-old with a \$100 million career is just unbelievable to me," said Jamieson following the milestone. "I've had some great memories in races I've won on my own and with my dad (Carl).

"I remember when John Campbell went to over the \$100 million mark," said Jamieson. "He set the bar. We've all, as drivers, dreamed of somewhere, someday attaining something comparable to him. Obviously he's gone into the stratosphere with over \$280 million made."

Jamieson has driven winners of more than \$3.7 million in purses this year and is currently the leading money-earning driver in Canada.

His largest victories came in the 2008 and 2011 North America Cup aboard Tell All and Up The Credit. The latter was trained by his father, Carl Jamieson.

In 2009, Jamieson set a Canadian record for most driving wins in a single season, visiting the winner's circle 796 times.

The Moffat resident also captured the World Driving Championship in Finland and Sweden in 2001. He has 6,628 career victories.

## Top Two Drivers Battle at Meadows, and Palone Comes out On Top

Corey Callahan and Dave Palone came into last night's action tied for the top spot in the national drivers' standings at 417 wins apiece. And their showdown at The Meadows resulted in Palone taking over the top spot.

Palone had three wins on the night to one for Callahan. That gave him 420 victories on the year, two more than Callahan. With Callahan piling up the bulk of his wins at Dover Downs, which is not currently open, Palone seems likely to draw off and win his second straight dash title.

## Coleman Celebrates Career Win 2,000

**CAMPBELLVILLE**, August 9 - It was a milestone night on Friday evening at Mohawk.

After driver Jody Jamieson celebrated \$100-million in career earnings as a driver in race two, trainer Casie Coleman notched her 2,000th win later on the card in race ten.

Coleman's Beat The Drum got under the wire first in a condition event for driver Scott Zeron in 1:53 to reach the 2,000 win plateau.

Coleman, a resident of Cambridge, has been named Canada's Trainer of the Year five times and has career earnings approaching \$45 million as a trainer.

"When I first came to Ontario, I never dreamed I'd win 1,000 races lifetime let alone 2,000 at my age," Coleman said. "It's pretty surreal to think that my team and I have accomplished this. It's just a great feeling."

The 33-year-old's top horses in recent years include North America Cup winner Sportswriter, Breeders Crown winner Betterthancheddar, Little Brown Jug winner Michaels Power, American Ideal, Art Colony, Idyllic and Moving Pictures, just to name a few.

## Report: David Brooks Must Forfeit \$60 Million

#### Should Be Another Easy Win For Bee A Magician

Bee A Magician will have no break after her powerful win last Saturday in the Hambetonian Oaks. The talented 3-year-old filly trotter headlines a series of Ontario Sire Stakes races tonight at Mohawk. She will go in Race 2, a \$150,000, event.

The only possible problem she figures to face tonight is the post as she drew the 10.

“It’s a tough spot for her, the ten-hole, that’ll be a bit of a test,” says trainer Nifty Norman, who conditions the Kadabra filly for Mel Hartman of Ottawa, Herb Liverman of Miami Beach, FL and David McDuffee of Delray Beach, FL. “Even though her form’s so good, it will still be tough. It’s never as simple as you think.”

That said, Bee A Magician is 2-5 in the morning line and it doesn’t look like there’s anyone in the field who can beat her—ten post or no 10 post. Bee A Magician has won all nine of her starts this year.

### Race 8, N/W \$8,000 L5 Pace

KINDLY POET is just three races removed from his 1:49:4; a career best at the age of 10. Classy gelding is within range of the \$1 million mark and he should figure at a price for Brethour on the dropdown. By all rights, ALSACE HANOVER should crush these after racing against the likes of Michaels Power and Aracache Hanover but he's yet to finish better than 7<sup>th</sup> in any of his starts this year. No excuses accepted; short price coming. BEACH RUNNER A M had late pace to offer in his most recent following the layoff but that was three weeks ago. SPEED AGAIN blew out weaker two back and then came up a bit short last week

ROAR makes his fifth start for Coleman after being trained previously by Toscano and it's hard not to see this one not figuring from the rail. Three back this one had zero chance against the likely favorite tonight and broke in his most recent; sandwiched in there is a sharp 1:50:2 win. Likely worth a swing. MACH IT SO is unbeaten for Norman since returning to Canada in June and this one has beaten almost everyone in here on more than one occasion. No matter the circumstance they haven't been able to touch him; deserving favorite. BLISSFUL BRO was shuffled in his last pair after showing good early speed; will be blasting once again and a smooth trip gives him an upset chance. BROCKS FORTUNE has come close on a couple different occasions to beating the fave; back to Waples tonight. GALLANT SEELSTER comes out of a strong showing at Rideau; might be stronger tonight than he was when last seen here.

### Race 10, Preferred Pace

CASIMIR JITTERBUG tripped out in his most recent to take a new lifetime mark and deserves a longshot look while stepping up for the third consecutive race. O'Sullivan's classy 6-year-old has been in this high before and his very best would give him a fighting chance; might be leaving. MICHAELS POWER has now won two in a row at this level after missing in his first two starts of the year; 2012 Jug winner is the obvious one to beat. ARACACHE HANOVER will likely be the trendy alternative to the fave as this one raced first over last week and held well to the wire; the outside post won't make it easy. It was just a couple months ago when FOOL ME ONCE paced the quickest of the NA Cup eliminations over this track when he won in 1:48:1 but I think this is a tough spot for the 3-year-old. I'd say ditto for SUNSHINE BEACH, but he did impress here in beating older foes on 6/29.

### Race 11, F&M N/W \$6,300 L5 Pace

ST LADS PEEPER went a number of big miles here last year and now drops to her lowest level in some time. This one was used early last week and then tired on the off-rated track; an honest try should be coming. BAROCKEY is another that drops after a couple tiring efforts; I have a hard time disregarding this barn. BEE FULL OF STEINAM is the recipient of a trainer change and while she broke last out; that :26:2 final quarter from two races ago stands out. GRACIE MONTANA flew through the stretch last week; probably won't offer anything to that price this week.

Leaving from post position number four, He's Watching took his time working his way to the front through an opening quarter of 27.

As the field headed towards the half mile mark of the race, He's Watching kept a snug hold of Morrill and continued through some brisk fractions posting a half mile mark in 54.4. Twin B Speedo (Yannick Gingras) was doing all he could do to keep within striking distance sitting in the two hole as the field went by three quarters in 1:22.4. Around the final turn, Morrill let the 2-year old son of American Ideal – Baberhood pace the final quarter and quickly step away from the rest of the field to win by six and a quarter lengths in a world record of 1:50. David Menary trains and co-owns He's Watching with Brad Gray and Michael Guerriero of Ontario.

"He is such a nice colt and he is just so fast it is unbelievable. I asked him to go in the stretch there tonight a little bit but he could have just as easily gone in 49 tonight, he is just so fast it's amazing" said drive Jim Morrill Jr. following the victory.

Three other divisions of NYSS for 2-year old colt pacers were held on Friday night at Tioga, the winners included: Neat – Marcus Miller (1:53.2), Major Trick – Jim Morrill Jr. (1:53.2), and Stay Up Late – David Miller (1:52.4).
