Winners And Losers in the Idyllic Story

The sport can be incredibly kind and incredibly cruel.

When **Idyllic** (American Ideal) turned in the biggest upset of the year, beating See You At Peelers (Bettor's Delight) in the Nadia Lobell at The Meadows Monday, school teacher Joe LaCova had another reason to celebrate, another reason to feel like the luckiest guy in the world. At that same moment, Jerry Giuliano wanted to cry.

LaCova is a school teacher from Long Island. He loves harness racing and his father, Michael, has owned horses for more than 40 years. But school teachers don't normally have a lot of disposable income, especially one who had just gotten married. He always wanted to own a horse, but could never afford to do so.

That changed when he won the fantasy football contest at his school. A special education teacher, he suddenly had \$1,400 that wasn't earmarked for the mortgage or the car payment. So he decided to spend it on a horse.

The elder LaCova used Casie Coleman as his trainer and asked her to find a claimer for himself and his son. She couldn't find anything she liked. So she suggested maybe the LaCovas would like to buy a yearling and steered them toward one by Cam's Card Shark. But Coleman reversed course and suggested they instead invested in a filly by American Ideal that she bought for just \$13,000.

For that little money, LaCova could afford to take his fantasy football winnings and parlay it into a horse. Along with his father, they bought a 25 percent interest in a filly named Idyllic. The other owners are Coleman and John Campagnuolo.

"I was a newlywed at time," LaCova said. "Didn't even tell my wife. I took the money and spent it on the horse and told her later, in the winter. She wasn't too happy."

Less than two years after he used his fantasy winnings to go in on Idyllic, LaCova is the co-owner of a horse who

has earned \$1,135,916, \$96,757 of it coming in the Nadia Lobell.

"I've been in business for 41 years and this is first horse I've had that amounted to anything and I get to own him with my son," Michael LaCova said. "It's been a great story for us."

Even Joe LaCova's wife has come around. He describes her as Idyllic's biggest fan and she did not fuss when her husband decided to use some of his racing winnings on more horses. He and his father went in on three more horses at last year's sales. Two, **Partner** (Ponder) and **Zellweger Bluechip** (American Ideal), have already made it to the winner's circle.

Giuliano is the co-breeder of Idyllic and, along with his wife, Diane, raced her mother, **Magical Dreamer** (Magical Mike). Not that it has put more than a few dollars in his pocket.

Magical Dreamer was injured and retired in 2002 after making \$167,044 in her career. Giuliano is friendly with Steve Stewart at Hunterton Farm and worked out a partnership agreement with him. The two went in together and bred the mare, first to Artsplace and then to Art Major.

The first foal, **Calchips Artist**, made \$11,160 on the track. The second sold for \$15,000 and never raced.

"Magical Dreamer was a very nice mare and made more than \$150,000 before she got injured," Giuliano said. "She had tremendous potential and that's why I decided to breed her. She just turned out small horses. But a horse doesn't have to be huge to be great."

The third foal was Idyllic, who brought that modest sum of \$13,000. Stewart had seen enough. He gave the mare away to the Amish.

"Steve is the one that gave the horse away, but I can't blame him," Giuliano said. "I agreed with his decision. I deserve just as much blame."

About the time Idyllic started tearing up the track, Stewart went back to the Amish buyer and tried to get the mare back. It was too late. She had died of colic.

It gets worse.

On the same card that featured Idyllic's win over See You At Peelers, Magical Dreamer's fourth foal won.

Named **Dream Of Winning** (Yankee Cruiser), she won a Pennsylvania Sires Stakes race to improve her career record to 5 for 7.

Had Stewart and Giuliano not given up on Magical Dreamer and given her away to the Amish, they would still own a broodmare worth a small fortune who might have produced a long line of horses that sold for serious money at the sales.

"It's a horrible story, one of the worst stories you could image," Giuliano said. "I still have that mare's papers and every time I look at them I get sick."

The only consolation for Giuliano is that he still owns Calchips Artist. With Idyllic and Dream Of Winning doing so well on the track her foals will have no doubt increased in value.

In the meantime, he's looking for long overdue good luck. Maybe he can borrow some of Joe Lacova's.

With Morrill Driving, Peelers Returns Sunday at Tioga

Coming off her first career loss, **See You At Peelers** (Bettor's Delight) will return to action Sunday at Tioga Downs in the sixth race, a \$49,235 New York Sires Stakes event.

Jim Morrill Jr., who was Peelers' regular driver in 2010 before being sidelined with an alcohol related suspension, has been named to drive. Replacing Marcus Johansson. Morrill will drive See You At Peelers for the first time this year.

See You At Peelers won her first 22 starts before tiring to finish sixth in the Nadia Lobell at The Meadows.

Meadowlands/Gural Update

Jeff Gural was supposed to "officially" take over at the Meadowlands yesterday, but he now expects that the "closing" between his group and the state of New Jersey will take place Sept. 25. In the meantime, the Sept. 1 date, originally the day the paperwork was going to be completed, was still the date Gural could make personnel changes. The NJSEA employees he will not be hiring for the new Meadowlands have been let go.

Gural's lease with the state will be for 31 years with two 10-year options.

Hunterton Client Purchases Top Mares

World Champion **Windylane Hanover**, in foal to Muscle Hill, and Merrie Annabelle winner **Miss Wisconsin**, carrying a foal by Donato Hanover, have been purchased by Ernie Gerbaulet, a Hunterton Farm and Sales Agency client who resides in Recklinghausen, Germany.

Hunterton's Steve Stewart, who made the announcement today, said "We are honored that Mr. Gerbaulet was able to purchase those mares and will be allowing us to help him fulfill his dreams of producing champions. It's always wonderful when a great

mare like Miss Wisconsin, who we bred, raised, and sold, returns home as a broodmare."

Windylane Hanover 2,1:57; 3,1:53 earned more than \$1.1-million on the track. She was a multiple stakes winner at both two and three, including the Hambletonian Oaks, and went on to being voted "Older Trotting Mare of the Year" as a four year old. She's one of harness racing's top-priced broodmares ever sold at public auction, bringing a final bid of \$600,000 at the 2006 Harrisburg Mixed Sale. Her first three foals sold for \$235,000, \$140,000 and \$125,000.

Miss Wisconsin 2,1:56.3; 3,1:55, a \$515,074-winning daughter of Muscles Yankee, sold as a yearling in Hunterton Sales Agency's 2004 consignment for \$150,000 and resold in the "Fabulous Fillies" section at the Harrisburg Mixed Sale two years later for \$485,000. Her own yearlings have sold for up to \$105,000.

Ray Schnittker trains and co-owns the winner of \$263,778 along with Charles Iannazzo. She paid \$2.40 for the win.

After making a break in her OSS Gold elimination in her most recent outing, Randy Waples guided Witch Way to her fourth victory this season.

The daughter of Ken Warkentin-Chelemark Gizmo

Fleet of foot stablemates Maureen Rocks and Laughandbehappy will go head-to-head Saturday at Mohawk Racetrack in the C\$100,000 A Spring Of Hope Invitational for trainer Tony O'Sullivan.

There's no doubting that both mares have speed to burn. Just how fast are they? The duo shares the track record for aged pacing mares with A Ps Money Maker and Sweet Hedge, each boasting sparkling 1:49.1 performances. Laughandbehappy notched the mark on July 16 and Maureen Rocks equaled it on August 19.

O'Sullivan believes Maureen Rocks is just coming into her own at four.

"I really believe she is actually just learning how to race and learning how fast she actually can go," he said.

The daughter of Rocknroll Hanover-Armbrro Maureen has 11 wins, two seconds and one third-place finish in 15 lifetime outings. She has banked \$139,000 for Emerald Highlands Farm.

"I think she will get better as the year goes on," said O'Sullivan. "She clearly has gotten better and I think next year if she stays healthy and sound, she can be a major player with the big girls."

Maureen Rocks has drawn the rail and will be driven by Scott Zeron, but driver Jody Jamieson and Laughandbehappy may have their work cut out for them from post nine.

"She's been burdened with some outside posts whenever the money is down it seems, but she is a good mare," said the Cambridge resident. "She can do it either way. If she is as good as she has been, she should be right there as well."

The 5-year-old daughter of Badlands Hanover-Zinful has a lifetime record of 26-6-7 in 52 starts and career earnings of \$514,008 for owners Let It Ride Stables Inc, Mentally Stable Inc, Robert Cooper Stables LLC and Jerry Silva.

The race is named after A Spring of Hope, a non-profit, international charity that raises money to help provide clean water sources for schools in South Africa.

The race was conceived as an Invitation and on the premise that in lieu of a Starting Fee, owners would be encouraged to make a donation to the charity.
