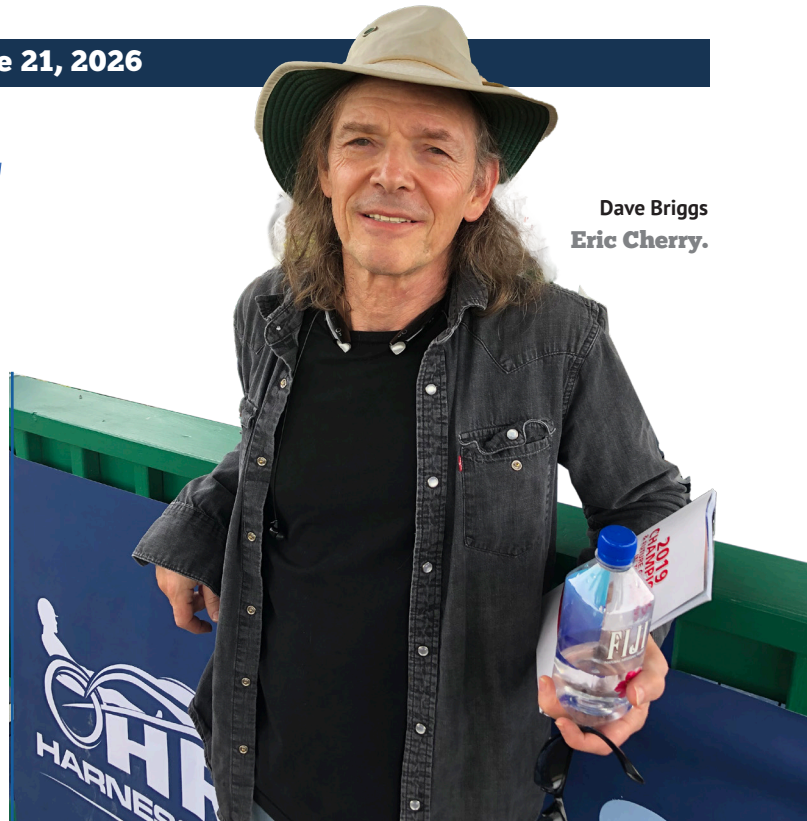

it be harness racing, any type of pari-mutuel racing, the lottery, casinos, prop betting, and any other form of entertainment, attempting to take a bite or two of the public's expendable cash.

"Every day is critical – just let this sink in – we are closer to 2050 than 1950."

*That's true. But our sport seems to need to do a lot more than just attract betting dollars. Don't you think we need programs that reach farther than the betting dollar?*

"Absolutely. Of course, we need to promote our sport. We have a vehicle to provide wonderful entertainment – family entertainment – that creates jobs, both directly and indirectly, between the veterinarians, caretakers, suppliers, and transportation personnel."

*Look at Oak Grove and their outreach to their surrounding communities. In cooperation with the United States Harness Driving Club, on their charity donation days; they draw an extra 30-40 people of all ages getting backstretch tours, starting gate rides, visits to the announcers booth and more along with the winner's circle presentation and check presentation. Put a few of those together and you've got a crowd at the track.*

"Yes, It's the trickle-down effect reaching the people that are vital to our sport and economy."

### **Farms, too.**

"And farms are a way to create green space and that, in turn, creates the job that we need to fulfill the needs of this industry. We create the jobs that are vital to the farm and the economy."

*What's your take on all of the multiple-leg wagers? Personally, I think we have too many of them to do us any good. It's stretching the pari-mutuel pools very thin.*

"I think you're correct in your views here and I believe it is hurting long-term handle. Placement of these wagers is the key here.

"It's fine to have some early in the card and some late in the card, however, if a bettor is 'alive,' they may sit on the sidelines to see how far they go.

"The problem is that there is only one takeout, whether it's three, four or five legs, or, maybe, even more."

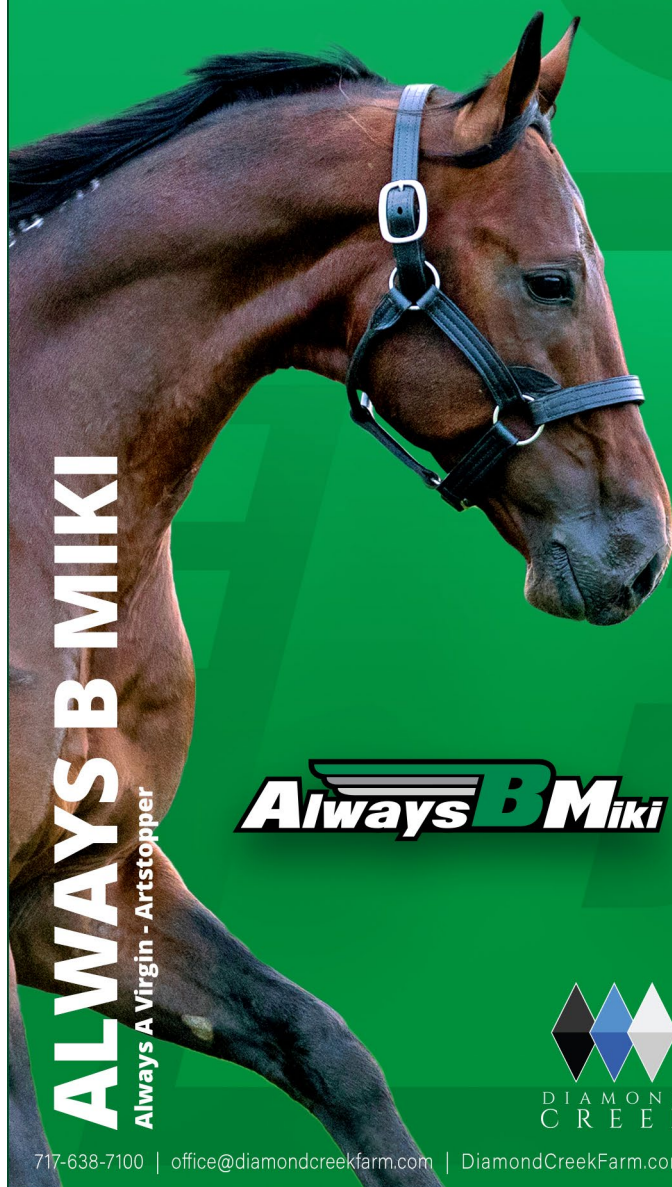

### So, what's your solution?

"Well, one option is to let the bettor choose their own customized parlays in as many races as they choose. We can afford to give a five per cent to 10 per cent premium compared to betting those races individually.

"This way, we can take multiple takeouts instead of just one.

"It gives the bettor the flexibility of playing the races in which they are interested.

"Look at the stock market; look at most of the other sports industries. They have evolved, harness racing has not done enough."

### What might be some other innovative ideas to improve our sport?

"Well, I've seen some of your suggestions – like the saddle pad extension to solve the whipping situation and things like that – but the things I am suggesting are geared to the betting public.

"First, block the tote board from the driver's view. Some drivers admit that they calculate their chances of winning by looking at the tote board instead of studying the program to drive their entries accordingly.

"Another may be *not* printing the morning line in the program.

"A solution for that might be to highlight the three possible favorites – but *not in order*.

"Also, do not allow the drivers to lean back until they are at the top of the stretch or if no other horse is behind them.

"We need tighter fields as many positions in the order of finish are decided by less than a foot; that's less than 12 inches.

"This will tighten the field and the competitive nature of the race."

***I have suggested that, if a redraw becomes necessary, one pill is drawn and all horses move out one post position. This would eliminate the possibility of a horse that drew the rail before the redraw getting the 8- or 9-hole, and that was soundly defeated.***

"Here's another one, have drivers decide which horses they will drive *before* post positions are drawn. I think that would create more competitive racing. Also, enforce a rule that drivers who pull outside must go forward.

"Many try to fish out some cover and clog the flow. Give 'em three or four seconds to go and, if they don't go, they are on their own and subject to a penalty."

### What kind of penalty?

“Well, if a driver gives another a hole in the first three-eighths-of-the-mile, they have their three or four seconds to pull and go forward themselves or they are fined the equivalent of five per cent of the winner’s share of the race.

“If they want to be polite and non-competitive, they should stay home.

“It’s a bad look for the bettors if they make a bet on a horse that isn’t given a chance.

“And one other thing, in maiden races, have the winner take 100 per cent of the purse, the whole thing.

“This will stop trainers from milking a class by finishing second or third all the time.

“This serves two purposes: The first is to give the owner a shot in the arm economically, and the second would protect the bettors from owners and trainers *trying* to finish second or third.”

Cherry has plenty more to say on making harness racing more exciting for our most precious commodity – the bettor – and we’ll cover those thoughts in Part 2.

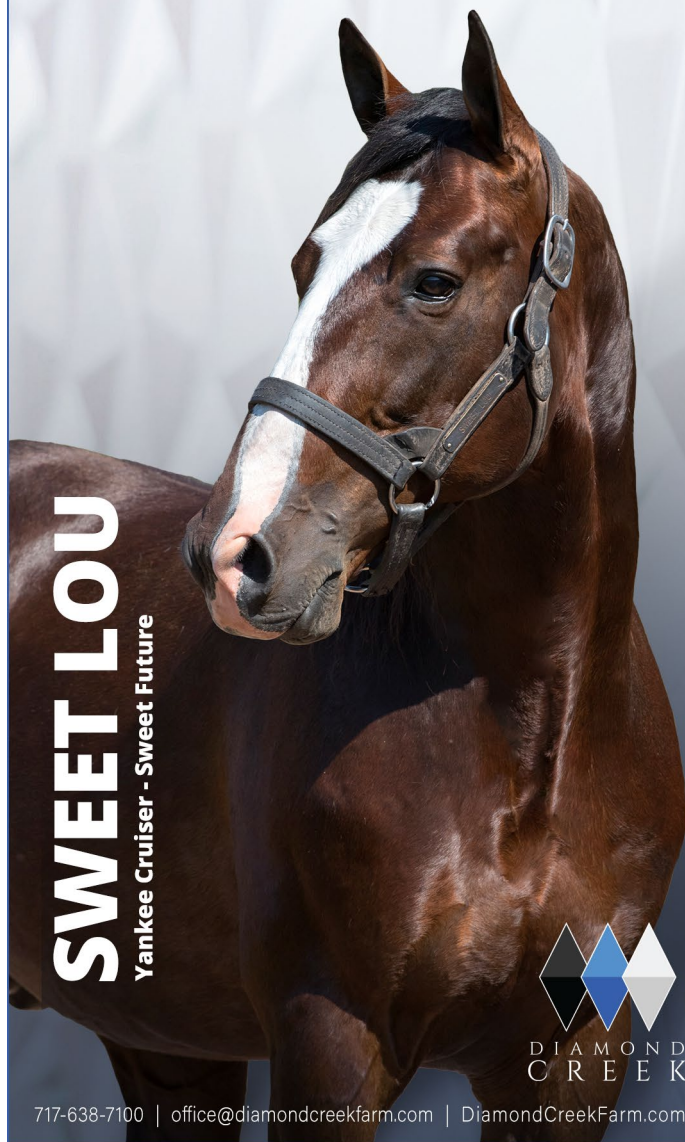

# A closer look at 'Mamba' and 'Norway'

Until the past couple of weekends, many thought Odds On Mr Mamba and On To Norway were Indiana standouts, not often translating to stardom on the national stage. That notion seems to have been put to rest with Odds On Mr Mamba taking down his North America Cup elim and final over Brandon Boulevard and defending HOY Beau Jangles. "Norway" won his Graduate leg on June 12 in a new career best of 1:49 3 with the greatest of ease stretching his incredible winning streak to 27.

Let's take a deeper dive into these Hoosier hotshots.

### ODDS ON MR MAMBA

1. A Feb. 17, 2023 homebred foal by owner Dana Parham's Odds On Nourrir of Boca Raton, FL was sired by Odds On Equuleus whose claim to fame was being second by a neck in the Metro to Captaintreachorous in 2012 and runner-up again the following year in the Meadowlands Pace also to the "Captain."

2. He was fourth in his career debut on July 30, 2025 but his :25.1 finale remains his quickest finish.

3. Melanie Wrenn just became the seventh female conditioner – nine Cups in total – to take the NA Cup.

4. Only once has he been in front at the first quarter marker and it was his biggest freshman win in the 250G INSS final.

5. His winning time of 1:48.1 last weekend in the Cup was not his lifetime mark.

6. He has never been passed in a race in 10 wins.

7. He's on a 10-race winning streak and was not favored in his career debut or either start in Canada.

8. He's not eligible to any of the Triple Crown races.

9. The closest finish in any of his 10-straight wins was a neck in his very wide but up-in-time NA CUP elim.

10. His combined margin of victory in his 10 rallies is 21¾ lengths.

### ON TO NORWAY

1. He had 27-straight victories heading into last night's (June 20) start at the Meadowlands in leg 3 of the Graduate. The first 26 were in Indiana with Hoosier Park hosting 25 and the Indianapolis Fairgrounds the other. That 1:53 flat effort at the fair marks the fastest trotting mile in the century-plus history of the grounds which once housed Greyhound.

2. His driver John De Long has what might be a record that will last a century or two, with 25 drives, 25 wins, favored every start, and all in the same state.

3. Three of his first four victories in the streak were for either \$12,500 or \$12,000.

4. Twice he's won a six-figure pot during the streak: \$185,000 in the Erskine on Oct. 31, 2025 and \$250,000 in the INSS final on Oct. 20, 2025.

5. He paid \$5.80, not the favorite, to start the streak on April 10, 2025 with Mike Peterson driving. The six-length margin in the first of 27-straight represents the biggest of the lot.

6. It's 443 days as of June 20, 2026 since he last tasted defeat at Hoosier Park.

7. He paid \$2.10 to win return seven times and \$2.20 eight times.

8. He was bred at Bennett Farms in Fremont, MI.

9. Here are the three drivers who have guided him during the streak: the aforementioned Mike Peterson, the most successful and busiest by far John DeLong with a spotless 25-race slate, and most recently Yannick Gingras who posted that sparkling 1.49.3 at The Meadowlands in his very first venture out of Indiana since his freshman season.

10. The farthest back he has been in any race during the streak is 6½ lengths on June 5 last year where he won by a half-length. Fittingly it was his closest win margin too. Twice he scored by a half-length, but never a nose, neck, or head during the streak.

# Hooley hopeful for Indiana Sires Stakes with Temporal Hanover tandem

Indiana fair circuit racing kicked off in the Crossroads of America in early June, with the first two rounds of competition conducted at the Converse Fairgrounds. Action switched to Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino last week, with fair contests for freshman and sophomore trotters and pacers sprinkled across four programs at the Anderson oval. Freshman Diamond Popper captured one of the divisions for 2-year-old trotters on the Tuesday (June 16) program for trainer Byron Hooley.

Diamond Popper passed through the sales ring at last year's Midwest Standardbred Horse Sale, but only managed a \$10,000 bid, was bought back by breeder John Lengacher, Jr. The colt, second foal from Credit Winner mare Etra De Vie, is from the eagerly-awaited first crop of Temporal Hanover. Hooley worked out a deal to purchase the colt privately after the sale.

"He said the colt didn't bring what he wanted, so they brought him home, and I latched onto him," said the owner/trainer. "He's happy, and so am I. Some of those guys don't have the big consignments and the advertisements like a lot of them do, and so I think he just kind of got lost there, and I like the Credit Winner. So, I took a chance on him."

Making his debut June 4 at Converse, Diamond Popper nearly broke his maiden. Steered by Hooley's son, Derek, the freshman engaged with Rebuff colt Skyway Storm in a spirited sprint to the finish before finishing a head back in 2:09.4.

"A month and a half ago, I had a lot of questions on him," the conditioner said. "He's pretty young [a May 18 foal], and he just seemed like a young 2-year-old. These last three, four weeks, he just seems to be blooming and blossoming. He has fun doing it, he's very easy to train, easy to be around, and he's still a colt. I left him a colt. I didn't have any reason to geld him at this point."

Hooley, who races under the banner of Summit Pacing Acres, didn't have to wait long to reach the winner's circle. Making his next start in a \$3,800 contest at Converse, the young

trotter wired the field to win by three-parts-of-a-length in 2:06. Diamond Popper’s time was the fastest of seven divisions for freshman trotters.

“I put trotting hobbles on him about three weeks ago, and that really helped him,” Hooley said. “He gained a lot of confidence, so that was a big step. I think that helped him a lot.”

Transitioning away from the half-mile fair tracks and smaller fields, Diamond Popper was saddled with post position 8 in a field of nine Tuesday at Hoosier Park. Hooley called upon John De Long, currently second in the driver standings, to pilot his

charge. Sent off as the narrow favorite over Doug Rideout’s Hidden Talent, De Long sent the trotter to the lead from the outside, clicking off a :30.2 first panel.

The duo dictated the tempo through fractions of 1:01.2 and 1:31.3. Up by more than four lengths at the top of the stretch, Diamond Popper cruised to a three-length margin over Hidden Talent at the wire, tripping the timer in 2:01.1. The mile was once again the fastest fair split for trotting colts.

“He seemed to go up to the gate nicely and had a good sense about it,” Hooley said. “John DeLong always does a good job.

Leaving from the 8-hole, I had no clue how that was going to be. That’s usually kind of a tough position. So that was a positive for him. He seemed to handle that and went to the top. It would have been nice to follow a horse, but I don’t think he’s going to be gate crazy where you leave with him a time or two and he’s going to get stupid. I think he’s very manageable. Derek drove him two starts at the fairs and he said that’s what he liked about him. He’s very drivable and had a good head on him. He wasn’t dashing here and there.”

With only a head separating the colt from a perfect three-for-three record, Hooley has Indiana Sires Stakes aspirations for his pupil. The first leg is slated for Thursday (July 9), and the owner knows that some of the better trotters are just now qualifying, or will do so in short order.

“I think I’ll probably give him a shot and see where he fits,” he said. “I think he’s going to be competitive.”

Hooley also has a Temporal Hanover filly that he is similarly pointing to sires stakes action. Satin Serenade is a homebred out of the owner’s champion trotter, Satin Dancer. On the track, Satin Dancer hit the board in 46 of 64 career starts, with 29 wins and earnings of \$739,640. The Grand Circuit winner captured the Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final at 2, and was runner-up at three in a season where she finished first or second in 16 of 19 attempts, with 12 trips to the winner’s circle. At age 4, Satin Dancer turned in a 1:51 effort in the Vincennes at The Meadowlands, trotting a neck behind winner Muscle Diamond.

“My goal with her is I’ve got her staked pretty heavily,” Hooley said. “I broke her and raised her, so I knew her from day one. She had a lot of Satin Dancer in her. Matter of fact, I took a picture of Satin Dancer’s head and took a picture of her head. They both have two swirls. They’re identical, I mean they’re in the exact same place. I thought, well, if she’s a remnant of what mom’s all about, I could handle that.”

In two starts at Converse, Satin Serenade registered a pair of runner-up finishes. In her debut she finished a neck behind fellow Temporal Hanover filly Sassytemper. On June 11, she was headed by Rebuff filly Rebuffpinklady in 2:01.3. The time established a new Converse track record. Satin Serenade was set for her first start over the Hoosier Park oval Thursday evening, drawing post 2 in the night’s fifth race. Severe storms in central Indiana forced track management to cancel after four races.

Satin Serenade is the fourth foal from the mare, who has two winners to her credit but has yet to produce a foal that emulates her ability as a racehorse. Hooley sold the previous foals, but has opted to campaign this filly, sending her to Travis Alexander to train over the winter. He hopes she can be competitive in the state’s top program and beyond.

“I think she’s going to be okay,” Hooley said. “You never know as time goes along. Right now, I wouldn’t want to have her in anybody else’s barn, let’s put it that way.”

# Mark MacDonald's driving and thriving back home in Canada

Mark MacDonald has been driving horses for well on 30 years. He still loves the competition among his peers and the beautiful steeds which they steer every bit as much as the first time that he first sat behind one in a race at the age of 16.

### *What has changed in those three decades?*

"An awful lot in so many areas:

- The horses: They are so much better in so many ways. They are faster. In many cases, much faster. They are able to carry their

speed longer and for lack of a better term, they are generally easier to get along with. Perhaps most importantly there are so many more good ones.

- The drivers: There are probably more good drivers out there than there were in the past. That's not to say that there haven't been great drivers in just about every generation. I know I'm leaving a lot of names out, but I'm just picking out a few names that stand out in my memory. Guys, like Campbell, O'Donnell, Lachance, Filion, Abbatiello and numerous others would have been great whenever they drove. The fact that there may be more of them than there were in the past probably speaks to our age of specialization.

- The racetracks: There are so many fewer of them today than when I was first starting out. Three that specifically touched on my career were Blue Bonnets, Windsor, and Greenwood. Of course, just this year, we've lost Rideau Carleton and all horse racing in British Columbia."

### *What else has changed?*

"The sport has become far more specialized. When I first came out, there were still a good many trainer/drivers. Now there are fewer. Drivers today, generally drive and trainers train.

"I first came out as a catch driver, although I was still training my own small stable, under one of the first great specialized

trainers in Bob McIntosh. Bob was not only one of the first of his genre, but to this day remains one of the very best ever.

“When I first began driving for Bob, I was so fortunate, and not only in being given the chance to drive for him. Here I was a young kid, barely out of his teens, given the chance to sit behind some of the very best young horses in North America. In addition, I was given the opportunity to learn from him as a horseman. I still had my own small stable then. I was able to better learn how horses should be treated by watching how it was done, by one of harness racing’s greatest horsemen.”

***Like several Maritimers you began working for Mike MacDonald in Montreal. What can you tell us about those days?***

“My brother Anthony and I began working for Mike [MacDonald, no relation] at Blue Bonnets. There were four of us sharing a small apartment in Montreal. We worked hard and we probably played just as hard.

I think I was just 16, but I already realized that harness racing was where I wanted to spend my working career. Aside from the native Prince Edward Islanders, there are too few people who realize how great a horseman and person that Mike MacDonald was. Many think that I probably learned the most from Bob McIntosh. That might be right. Bob was a great teacher. But without Mike MacDonald, I might never have even known or had the chance to drive Bob’s great horses. Mike taught everybody with who he came in contact how to interact with horses. If I had not worked for Mike, I doubt that I ever would have been able to start my own stable, nor likely would I have caught the eye of Bob McIntosh. I’ve carried Mike’s influence through my racing career, in that my racing colors trace back to those worn by Mike.

“I’m sure my brother Anthony would probably praise Mike, too.

“Mike’s PEI roots probably ruled his harness racing career. He won five Gold Cup and Saucers – more than anyone else. He did spend most of his racing career racing in Montreal, the New England states and in the other Maritime provinces, but it was in PEI where his heart was.”

***In terms of your catch driving career, from the outside looking in, it would probably be generally classified as three eras, those of the trainers Bob McIntosh, Casie Coleman, and Ray Schnittker. Would you agree?***

“I guess that probably would be right. Bob, started me off by giving me drives, on horses the likes of which I had only dreamed of someday driving. I then transitioned to driving some of Casie’s best horses like Sportswriter and American Ideal. I think even 20 years later, for pure speed, American Ideal might

have been the fastest horse I ever sat behind. Then, when I picked up my helmet, whip, and colors and moved south, I got the chance to regularly sit behind the horses in Ray Schnittker’s New York-based stable.”

***Just as those opportunities presented themselves, each of their denouements were somewhat similar in that their endings, so to speak, were marked by a horrific, some might say, nearly deadly accident on the racetrack. What effect, if any, have those accidents had on your psyche and on your ability to shunt them aside and go forward?***

“I’ve been unlucky in that I’ve found myself each time in the wrong place at the wrong time. There was nothing about those wrecks that was preordained or caused by human error,

by myself or by anybody else. They were events that normally occur in racing. In each of them, I unluckily found myself as the recipient of something that had happened beyond my control, or probably beyond the control of anybody else. Things happen, especially out on a racetrack.

“Indeed, I’ve been seriously injured at least four times, where initially the prognosis was far from great. I’ve been fortunate in that the road to recovery from each event has been excellent. I now find myself at 47 feeling as good as I’ve ever been. I still look forward to each day whether it is on the racetrack or sometimes on the golf course. I find both my body and my mind raring for action.”

### ***You are back in Canada where it all started. What led you back home?***

“My last racing accident resulted in my being out of action for a year, the longest I’ve gone without competing on the racetrack. I thought maybe a change in scenery might be in order. What better place than in my native land?”

“Things have worked out well. I’m getting drives. I think I’m driving well and winning my share of races. The competition up here is very strong.

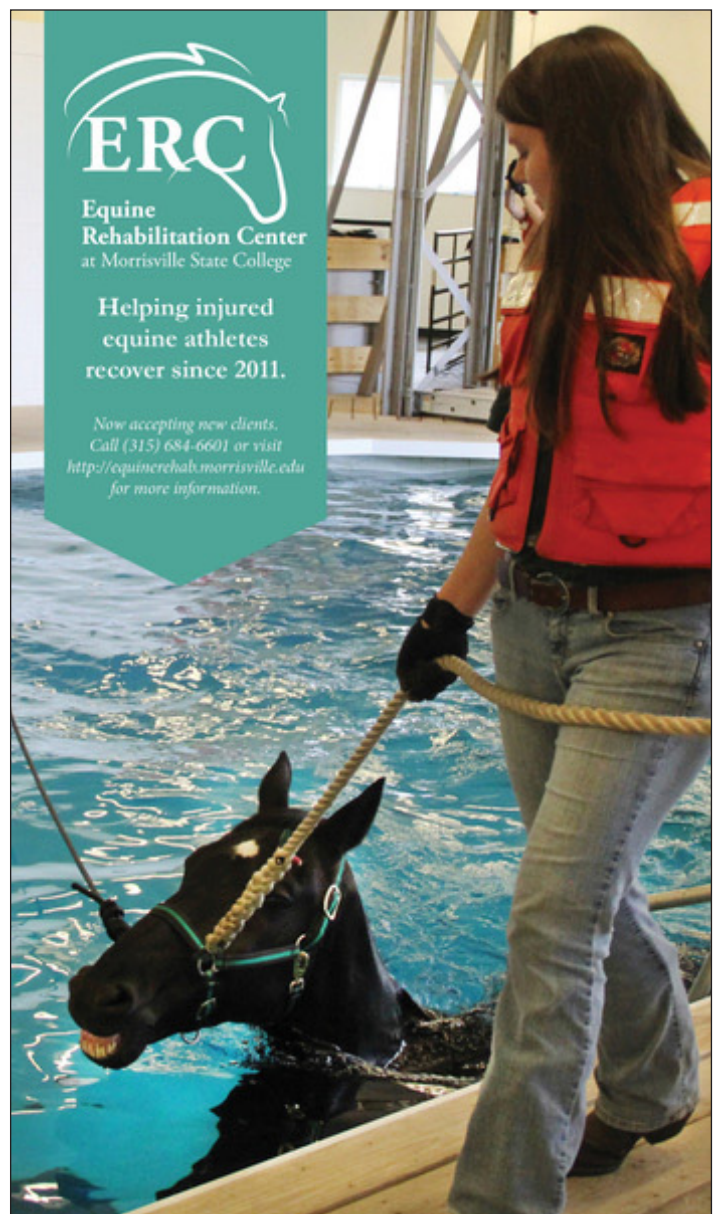
“It’s a little different than it was when I was last here. Back then, among my greatest competition on the track were guys like Rick Zeron and Paul MacDonell. Now instead of competing against them, I’m sometimes driving for them on horses that they train.

“One of the biggest differentials is in the driving colony. Back then guys like Steve Condren and Doug Brown and the aforementioned Zeron and MacDonell led the pack. Now it’s the youngest MacDonald, my brother James, who not only up here, but arguably, together with Dexter Dunn, might be among the very best reinsmen in the world.”

### ***We’ll close with James and his success. Does any of it surprise you?***

“Not at all. Although, James started in harness racing later than me or Anthony, he is the most naturally gifted athlete among us. He started working for Anthony after he had shown talents in golf and hockey, but he was a natural in harness racing from the start. In addition to his great athleticism, James is blessed with a great nervous system and remarkable patience. Horses know when they are being guided by someone who relates to their best instincts. That is the case with James and I believe to a lesser degree, with all great drivers.”

# Beach Towel's million-dollar plus victory in the Meadowlands Pace is still riveting

I remember the hoopla going around and the anticipation of the 1990 million-dollar-plus Meadowlands Pace. Not just for the great field it drew and the anticipation of one great standardbred's dominance over the lot as he headed for historic notation, but for me, the event was a professional growth experience; all to do with my transformation from a casual-turned-serious pari-mutuel racing gambler to a professional journalist in an industry of dedicated people on the backstretch, and on the tracks, and on farms all over the world.

The human element in the 14th edition of the event included distinct personalities I would meet and work with behind the scenes – which is the territory where I was comfortable and performed best during my former Hollywood years.

Of course in the spotlight was a spectacular harness horse race starring a tame-named colt that proved to be a beast of a pacer: Beach Towel.

But I digress.

The new decade of the '90s was not short of world-shaking events. The Berlin Wall fell. Europe was shaking from a collapse of communism. Students marched for democracy in China. U.S. troops invaded Panama. Millions of gallons of oil spilled off the coast of Alaska in an historic environmental disaster. A World Series game in San Francisco was delayed by an earthquake. And on and on.

Not making headlines or history was my new life in Pennsylvania as a standardbred-sports journalist after decades of commercially accepted creative writing. I was physically closer to The Meadowlands than I was since when I left New York 11 years before. But in Pennsylvania by mid-July of '90 I was an assistant editor of *TIMES: in harness*, a

new standardbred publication. The 1990 Meadowlands Pace was a giant industry news event and my first exposure to the industry's landmarks. The purse was \$1,153,500. Huge considering that is \$2,759,569.38 in 2026.

I did not travel to New Jersey to report the race; even though *TIMES*: had strong connections to Joe DeFrank, the race's founder and the track's race secretary who was also a share-holder in *TIMES*:. I was landlocked in rural Pennsylvania juggling deadlines as part of a small staff. I went to the local racetrack – Penn National – to cover the race via simulcast.

I strolled the grandstand on the second floor. It was obvious from the chatter that there were local bettors waiting for The Meadowlands event while juggling bets on the local thoroughbred program. The buzz about the race was the rivalry of two pacers: Beach Towel versus Jake And Elwood.

Having an overblown creative writing background I was not thrilled with the name Beach Towel. It was not as exciting or heroic as I preferred. As for Jake And Elwood? Naming a racehorse after two cartoon-like fictional comics was just silly. I preferred dramatic racehorse names; at least for colt racehorses. Equine athletes' names, according to me, should include words like Strong and Mighty and King and Thunder. Not that I would rate a colt poorly if I considered its name weak. Petty. But I just have this thing about names that goes back to my adventure-reading thrills as a child. Beach Towel was not the first racehorse name I judged unfairly. I did not like the name Secretariat either. And I still do not.

Speaking of names. Beach Towel's pedigree was full of horse names unknown to me. Some I liked and some I did not. But I was still learning about standardbred bloodlines in the industry. Much information came from my new workmates, specifically John Bradley and James Harrison's landmark volume of inherent equine relations. I needed to learn more and more about bloodlines because it was not the area of knowledge deemed important to the common betting ilk I frequented on either coast. To help me focus on my education I decided not to handicap or bet the Meadowlands Pace and to watch it as an objective reporter; as a member of the industry's insiders.

At Penn National I stationed myself beneath a large TV screen well before the race so I would not be crunched between the bettors and their breadths of rowdies rooting for the horses they backed once the race was off. From the start it was a strong story. Beach Towel by any other name was an impressive four-legged Pegasus. Driver Ray Remmen allowed his steed to take control of the two-turn path with no intention of letting any of his foes cross the wire before him. And in each quarter, it was Beach Towel

stepping faster and faster and having more than enough speed to thwart Jack And Elwood and the other sophomore colts.

Beach Towel laughed at my petty name judging. I deserved it. I bowed in the general direction of the beast so that when the time came to report on the 1991 Meadowlands Pace I said, "Precious Bunny?" What is in a name?

After all, not every powerful 3-year-old pacer can have the all-time perfect name for his ilk. Yup. I mean Nihilator.

# Harness racing has taken Claudia Jacques on quite a ride

Claudia Jacques joined the standardbred racing world in the most unexpected way.

After graduating from high school in her native Quebec, the horse-loving teenager set out to further her equine education at the collegiate level. She focused on attending ferme-école LAPOKITA, a non-profit educational farm affiliated with the Institut de technologie agroalimentaire du Québec (ITAQ) campus in La Pocatière, north of Quebec City.

"I have always loved horses since I was about 3," Jacques said. "They have always been my favorite animal. After high school,

I focused on attending a college that provides a program and courses focused on riding horses."

In horse racing parlance, however, her chances of getting into her preferred program were a longshot.

"They only take 40 students a year," Jacques said. "There are 10 in harness racing, 10 in western, 10 in pleasure and 10 in jumpers. Unfortunately, I was the 11th one in the riding horse program. But they told me they had an opening in the harness racing one and if I would be interested in taking one session, the next semester I could switch to the riding horses program.

"I had no clue about harness racing. But I thought I should do it because I was going to be in the college anyway. I figured I would do the harness one and then move on to the other program."

Those plans quickly changed.

"I fell in love with harness racing the first time I sat behind a horse," Jacques said. "With this program, you break babies. They also had two older horses where you learned about equipment and other things. I had no clue what the equipment was and had to learn a lot, but I enjoyed it. I never went back to riding horses again."

The riding horse world's loss became the standardbred world's gain.

After graduation, Jacques set her sights on Ontario.

“Once I finished college, my friend and I moved to Ontario,” she said. “The business back then in Quebec was okay, but we knew we needed to go to Ontario for work. So, we decided to learn English, move to Ontario and then figured we would move back to Quebec in a year.”

The return trip never happened.

“Here are I am, now 20 years later,” Jacques said with a laugh.

She has worked for several notable trainers over her time in Canada’s most populous province.

“When I first moved here, I started with Rick Zeron because he knew my teacher in Quebec,” Jacques said. “He spoke with my teacher to learn some more about me and then I went to work in his barn. I went on to work for Herb Holland and Rob Fellows.”

Once again, Jacques had to change course, a move based on necessity rather than want.

Another career shift came in 2012 when Ontario’s Slots at Racetracks program was discontinued. Like many others in the industry, Jacques was forced to reconsider her future in racing.

She would still have ties to racing over the next seven years, but in a part-time, limited role.

“I had my own cleaning business during the time I was away from racing,” she said. “I was still doing paddocks and things like that, but it wasn’t on a full-time basis.”

When the COVID-19 pandemic arrived in 2020, Jacques found herself at another crossroads. After careful consideration, she decided to return to the barn.

“At first, it was part-time, then it became a full-time job again, with Ted MacDonnell,” she said. “Eventually, I went to work with Garry [her husband, trainer Merner]. He had started his own stable and was slowly building it. We had a small number of horses at the time, but it was nice to be back in the business again.”

An industry that has always felt like home for Jacques.

These days, she is busier than ever, taking care of six horses in the bustling Merner stable.

She takes immense pride in her role as a caretaker and places the welfare of her horses above all else.

“I just make sure things are done right,” she said. “It is our own business, so you are the last one there at night, making sure you have to check everything off the list of things that need to be completed. I work closely with Wayne Hafey because he is the second trainer for Garry.”

Jacques also enjoys mentoring newer caretakers in the barn.

“I have 20-odd years of experience and that does count for something,” Jacques said. “If I can help guide the staff – and we have great people – and maybe offer some advice or listen to their questions, that makes me happy. They know what they are doing, but maybe you have learned something over the years that can be helpful to them.”

When it comes to the horses under her care, Jacques refuses to play favorites, even when one of them is a standout performer like Ayeaye Captain Deo, the son of Captaintreacherous who recently captured the \$101,250 Graduate Series at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

“I treat them all the same,” she said. “I always have. Whether it is Ayeaye Captain Deo, Nova Blu, or one racing in claiming, they are equal in my eyes. They get the same care, same love, and same everything. They don’t know they are fast or what level they are racing at. What they do have is their own personalities and they deserve to be treated the same way.”

That level of attention and care starts the moment Jacques sets foot in the shedrow.

“The best part [of my job] is when I come into the barn in the morning,” she said. “It may sound silly, but when I see the

horses with their heads sticking out of their stalls and they are nickering at me, I just love that. They are happy to see me, they want attention and I am happy to give them that. It’s as though they are saying, ‘This is my mom.’ The love you get back from your horses is wonderful.

“I would say the most challenging part is when you have done so much work as a team and then the result isn’t what you hoped it would be. Obviously, it takes a lot of work to make sure the horses are happy and healthy, and to get them prepared to race. The time, effort, and hours you put in makes you feel disappointed when it doesn’t work out.”

Even during those difficult moments, Jacques finds fulfillment in knowing she has discovered her true calling, one she never expected to find.

“I didn’t expect this would be the way I would work with horses, but I am so happy that I am here,” Jacques said. “I am grateful every day.”

# A tough Ontario winter worked wonders for Gary Hodgson and Cleopanther

There are a million clichés to describe the slight-of-stature athlete with a will to win more powerful than any physical attribute, but hobby trainer Gary Hodgson didn't need any of them to realize he had something special in Cleopanther.

"She always seemed to be so competitive, she wanted to do it," Hodgson said. "Even with the better horses, she'd never give up. One would go by her, and she just kept going. She doesn't quit.

"She's a small horse, really small. But she's got a big heart."

Hodgson never found himself questioning what he had in the daughter of Panther Hanover—Im Stunning, who made a lasting first impression with her mature demeanor.

"Her attitude stuck out to me right away," he said. "From the start, she seemed to really enjoy going out on the track and that made her easy to break. The first time she was in the harness, we walked around a couple of times, and she responded so well that we put the jogger on and walked her around some more.

"The next day, same thing, back in the jogger. I had two leads on her, took her for half a mile, and we just unhooked her – away she went."

Cleopanther's natural instincts between the rails were especially evident during her time with revered father-and-son trainer-and-driver team Carl and Jody Jamieson.

Carl, who was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in 2013, and Jody, a lifetime earner of more than \$158 million in purses, helped season the bay pacer at their Florida training center in 2024.

"I had her down at Carl's to put her on the gate the first time she was in a jogger," Hodgson said. "Jody took her around and she was perfect.

"I've been really lucky to have Carl and his crew help me with every horse I've had. Jody's been the first guy to put every horse I've owned behind the gate to help break them. To have guys like that in your corner, boy, it's amazing."

Encouraged by a strong showing at the Jamieson school of racing, Hodgson elevated Cleopanther to Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots competition in just her second career start.

The then 2-year-old pacer held her own, finishing third at Woodbine Mohawk Park on July 7, 2025.

Hodgson, despite being surprised by the level of competition in a debut Grassroots leg, elected to give Cleopanther another shot the following week.

After a seventh-placed result in leg 2, the London, ON-based conditioner decided a step down was in order.

"I didn't want to dishearten her because she wants to win," he said. "That's why I chose to go into the [Ontario Sires Stakes] Prospect Series and see how she did."

Sent off as the 4-5 choice in her Prospect debut last September at Hanover, the stars were aligning, at least, on paper, for Cleopanther.

However, it just wasn't meant to be.

"Then, of course, we had some bad luck," Hodgson said. "We had broken equipment in the one I thought we were going to win. I thought that was going to be a good move for her, but it didn't work out."

The unfortunate turn of fortune prompted Hodgson to press the reset button at year's end – and change his approach for the first time in a quarter century.

"As a 3-year-old, I decided to start her out a little easier," he said, adding with a laugh, "This is the first time I didn't go down to Florida in 25 years – I'm not going to do that again."

“It was a tough winter, but on the bright side, she trained well all the way through and that made the decision much easier.”

While there wasn’t a noticeable physical transformation between ages 2 and 3 for Cleopanther, Hodgson wholeheartedly believes she already has everything she needs to be successful in her niche.

“She’s always had the will to go, and she’s always had the will to win, so there’s not much of a difference,” he said. “She didn’t grow much, and that’ll make things tougher on her, but I’m pretty sure she’ll race well at the smaller tracks.

“I really like the way she gets around the half-mile tracks, so I’m planning on sticking to them going forward.”

Hodgson’s plan, and faith, have both been validated through the early stages of 2026, as Cleopanther sports a 1-2-0 line from four starts this season.

The notch in the win column came in a true-to-form, gritty maiden-breaking triumph in the first leg of the Little Saratoga Pacing Series on June 7 at Dresden Raceway.

Finally, everything had come together for Cleopanther.

“I really felt good going in,” Hodgson said. “I really felt good about the driver [Lorne House]. He’s a great driver and he’s light. She’s a small horse, and he likes to leave a little bit and give her a chance. That’s what I liked about Lorne. He’d give her a chance. He’d get her in place to do something good, and boy did she.”

While his heart rate spiked on a few occasions, Hodgson was elated by the performance he knew his fierce filly was always capable of.

“I was pretty excited, there’s no doubt about that,” Hodgson said. “I think she still had a little more in her because she still had her earplugs in. I was really happy seeing her come around the bend with two lengths on them. When Lorne didn’t pull the earplugs, I thought, ‘She’s going to win this one easy.’”

The 2½-length victory gave Hodgson a glimpse of what the remainder of Cleopanther’s sophomore campaign may have in store.

“I’d like to get back into the Grassroots,” he said. “That’s what I’d love to do, but we’ll see. We’ll give her a shot if we have a half-mile to go on.”

With a plan in place for the leader of his two-horse outfit, Hodgson, at age 77, has no intentions of slowing down.

“I’ve been in it since the ‘90s,” he said. “I retired in 2000 and got out of the game for eight years driving stock cars, but I got back into doing this because I like being around the horses and I like racing.

“Racing the stock cars got a little tough, getting knocked around there pretty good. But I enjoy getting up in the morning and coming out to the barn. It’s something exciting to wake up to every day.”

In the next few weeks, Hodgson will have Cleopanther’s half-brother Loucksy, a 2-year-old Sunshine Beach bay, also bred by Cynthia Graham, joining the mix.

“I really like the two horses I have,” he said. “They were both raised by Cynthia, who I had a horse from before these two named Miss Brickley. I’ll tell you, she must be something special because each horse is just unbelievable to handle.”

That reliability, says the hobbyist of 30-plus years, has shone through in spades with Cleopanther.

“I like to have a horse that’s going to compete and stay healthy, and she does that,” Hodgson said. “She’s a healthy, strong little horse. She hardly needs any vet work. She takes care of herself. She eats well, she travels well, she does everything right.

“She’s been one of the best horses I’ve ever owned.”

# Nero, Scorpus, Diocles, and Crescens

*More harness ghosts of the past.*

Two thousand years ago, chariot racing was the greatest game in town. The young men holding the reins could become richer than senators, more famous than generals. If you look at the graphic, the driver's stance was surprisingly athletic, knees bent, and leaning back against the pull of the horses. A Roman driver essentially water-skied behind horses while standing in a lightweight wooden vehicle.

The number of horses in the team varied; a quadriga was four horses abreast. A two-horse, like the one in the graphic, was referred to as a biga. Three horses made a triga, and six made a seiuga. Drivers wore helmets, team colors, and a body wrap or padded tunic. The reins were wrapped around the waist for leverage, especially with three or more horses. They carried a knife to cut themselves free if they crashed. These races appear to be less like a jog around the track and more like a combat mission.

Let's take a closer look at a few famous drivers who had unique stories.

From Oct. 13, AD 54, until June 9, AD 68, the Roman Empire was ruled by a chap named Nero. An interesting fellow, he was the fifth Roman emperor, stepson and heir to Claudius. Surrounded by a terrorized cast of sycophants, Nero kept busy with debauchery, extravagance, vengeance, and possibly the burning of Rome.

Nero had a bit of an ego and did not enjoy being upstaged. When the Olympics were scheduled in the year 64 AD, Nero entered the chariot races. The emperor did not appear to be a great athlete, more like a guy in a plus-size toga who would struggle to climb two steps to reach a banquet table for more wine and cheese.

Nero raced to the beat of his own drum. After a pre-race chat with the officials, he showed up on race day with 10 horses, far more than the rules allowed. When the race began, Emperor Nero managed to fall out of his chariot (disqualifying), had other people help him back aboard (disqualifying), and never finished the race.

Emperor Nero was a resourceful chap, so despite his efforts in the race, he declared himself the winner of the race, claiming that his mere participation was good enough. His forum quorum enthusiastically endorsed his victory. In fact, he entered several

Crescens was cool. This chariot driver was a Moor from North Africa who became one of Rome's leading drivers. He raced for the blues, stayed true to his team, and accumulated hundreds of victories. He was a notable exception to the class system; unlike politics or the Senate, he learned that racing cared more about talent than birth. A young man from the edge of the empire became a celebrity in Rome.

Knowledge about ancient sporting events is not easy to find, but Roman racing left a surprising paper trail. In addition to writing, tombstones, mosaics, inscriptions, bronze figurines, and even lead curse tablets (a tablet carried to wish bad luck on the other team) preserve the names of drivers and horses. In many cases, we know more about the careers of elite Roman charioteers than we do about medieval kings.

Tombstones and racing inscriptions are primary sources, especially for Diocles, who had people recording his race starts, wins, earnings, notable victories, and the patrons he drove for. It reads almost like a modern USTA statistical summary. Mosaics identify driver names, horse names, and victory scenes of drivers holding palm branches.

Hey, Yannick, Timmy, David, and Dexter – would you like to walk a mile in those sandals?

more Olympic events, won them all, and his records stood for a few centuries until they were permanently erased from the public record.

The greatest star of the Circus Maximus wasn't an emperor. He wasn't a senator. He wasn't even a soldier. He was a chariot driver named Flavius Scorpus, a young man who won approximately 2,000 races before dying in a crash at age 27.

The young superstar built his reputation charging into the turns where races were often won or lost. The Romans even had a special word for the carnage that sometimes happened, naufragium, meaning "shipwreck." The term originally described the destruction of vessels at sea. Race fans borrowed the word for the violent pileups that occurred when chariots clipped wheels, horses tangled, and entire fields collapsed into chaos.

Scorpus may have been Rome's most beloved driver, but a chariot driver from Portugal, Gaius Appuleius Diocles, had longevity. During a career spanning a quarter century, Diocles competed in more than 4,200 races and won nearly 1,500 of them. He amassed a fortune so large that modern historians still debate how to translate it into today's dollars.

Like modern free agents, Diocles was a bit of a mercenary who often switched factions during his career. One year he was a hero for the yellows, the next year he was for the reds. Two thousand years before professional athletes signed eight-figure free agent contracts, Diocles proved that speed, courage, smarts, and a knack for winning could make a sports star fabulously wealthy.

# Long Tom fillies sweep Ohio Sires Stakes

Long-shot daughters of Long Tom swept the two \$75,000 divisions of the Ohio Sires Stakes for 3-year-old filly trotters, both setting new lifetime marks in the process. The races held Thursday (June 18) at Eldorado Scioto Downs were won by **Mooter Tooter** (1:54.2) and **Charlotte Elise** (1:55.2).

The first OHSS division had quite a bit of action getting off the gate, going to the :27.4 opening quarter as Joyofmylife As (Tony Hall) made the early lead but quickly settled behind Rose Run Brooke (Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.). Faster Horses (Jeremy Smith) put on the pressure from post 9 and took over going into the second turn towards the :56.1 half. Mooter Tooter was sitting fifth and flushed out the cover of Seven Lick Range (Tyler Smith) as the field went down the backside towards the 1:25.2 third quarter. Tipping three-wide off the last turn, Mooter Tooter had the momentum to win by 2¾ lengths over Seven Lick Range; Rose Run Brooke was third.

Mooter Tooter went off at 27-1 and paid \$56.40 to win. Ron Burke trains the daughter out of Moots (by Andover Hall) who was a \$28,000 Ohio Selected Yearling Sale purchase from breeder Wayne Weaver. Owned by Burke Racing, Knox Services, Beasty, and R A S Racing, Mooter Tooter now has \$72,350 earned in her 15 lifetime starts with three victories.

The other division went to Charlotte Elise (T. Smith) in 1:55.2. The race winner got away fifth as Speedbewithyou (Austin Hanners) got to the :28.4 opening quarter first. Setyoursightshigh (Mike Wilder) made the front shortly thereafter and led the field towards the :57.3 half as Charlotte Elise came first up going into the second turn. Going toe-to-toe at the 1:26.4 third quarter, Charlotte Elise and Setyoursightshigh put slight separation between themselves and the rest of the field. Coming down to the wire, Charlotte Elise outsprinted the even-money-race favorite, winning by a length and three-quarters; Guardian Doll (Ronnie Gillespie) was third.

Charlotte Elise set her new lifetime mark winning just her second race in 11 lifetime starts. Trained by Micah Miller, Charlotte Elise has now earned \$56,060 for owners Wayne

Mast, Jr., Callam Racing, Jeremy Miller, and Joseph Mast. Out of the Cayenne Turbo mare Here's Jolene, Charlotte Elise was a \$62,000 Ohio Selected Yearling Sale purchase from Albert Miller. Going off at 43-1, Charlotte Elise paid \$88 to win.

The 91-day 2026 Eldorado Scioto Downs regular season runs through Sept. 19. Races are held Tuesday-Saturday, with a special holiday card on Labor Day instead of the Tuesday card that week. The track will then re-open for the Breeders Crown, with eliminations held Oct. 16-17 and the finals Oct. 23-24. ## Loua Dipa, Miss Jum Jabber pass winners at Pocono

**Loua Dipa** and **Miss Jum Jabber**, the two “big fillies,” won as expected in Saturday’s (June 20) third preliminary of the Pennsylvania Sire Stake for sophomore pacing misses, worth \$106,254 over two divisions, at Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania. Both stopped the clock in 1:50.3, with supercharged back half speed; both won by a half-length, but looked to be more in control than the margin may suggest.

Loua Dipa, the Sweet Lou filly who was No. 2 in the first Top Ten poll of the season after her championship freshman campaign and coming off a victory in the Fan Hanover final, was on the move off the first turn, made the top, and got a breather to the half. Her last splits of :54 - :26.2 left all in the field far behind save one – Darlin’s Angel, who won her only other Sire Stakes start but hadn’t raced in 40 days. The pocket horse kept right with the star pacesetter all the way to the wire in an excellent performance, but driver Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. did not seem to wonder whether his filly would stay on.

Loua Dipa, winning in the PASS for the first time in 2026, is conditioned by Ron Burke (we’ll hear more about “The Two Ronnies” later) for the Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Brusceci LLC partnership.

When we say that Loua Dipa had not won a 2026 Sire Stakes before Saturday, this does not mean she hadn’t entered one. She made her seasonal debut in a PASS at Philly May 1 – as Miss Jum Jabber had her “coming-out party” that day by defeating the champion by a head.

A Bettor’s Wish filly trained by Brett Pelling for his Pelling Racing LLC, Miss Jum Jabber did not race at 2, lost her career bow (though coming her last quarter in :25), and has since gone on to win all eight of her starts, including the earlier photoing of Loua Dipa and Saturday’s Pocono victory. Miss Jum Jabber does not show a “1” at the quarter in her program lines, and indeed driver Andrew McCarthy reserved her in fourth through the first half mile.

A tug on the right line had “MJJ” out and bursting up towards the leader while pacing her own third split in :26.1, and she continued with a final quarter of :27 (with head characteristically

cocked a bit to the right) to overhaul a very stubborn pacesetter I’m A Lou Lou (trained by Burke). The two great fillies don’t have their next possible Sire Stakes meeting until Aug. 27 (a week before the \$300G championship on Sept. 6), but they may clash on the Grand Circuit before that.

We mentioned “The Two Ronnies” as the combination of Wrenn and Burke (and not the beloved British comedy duo), and they

came very close to sweeping the four \$20,000 divisions of the complementary Stallion Series action, taking the first three cuts including the fastest with the Papi Rob Hanover filly Real Fast in a lifetime best 1:51.2. This division matched Real Fast and Tall Dark Tequila, the double winners in the Stallion Series to date, with the former setting the pace then booming home in :55.2 to beat the latter for Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Brusceci LLC, Knox Services Inc., and Slaughter Racing Stable LLC.

Another filly co-owned by Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Brusceci LLC (this one with Lawrence Karr and Phil Collura), **Sandyboots Yankee**, got into contention by going her own third quarter raw in :26.3 then pacing right away to lower her mark to 1:52.2 for The Two Ronnies; they also were the team behind 9-1 upsetter **With The Fur**, a Tall Dark Stranger filly who came from five lengths back at the half to reduce her mark to 1:54 for owner Howard Taylor.

“Team Ronnie” had the chalk in the final StS cut in looking for the four-bagger in those races, but their horse made an early break, leaving the door open for trainer Brett Pelling to get a victory in both sections of the PA-sired action with the Captaintreacherous filly **Gracious**. She won in a career best 1:52.3, getting some late

left-side taps from driver Brett Beckwith in gaining the triumph for Diamond Creek Racing.

Haltered for \$23,000 after winning his third straight against claiming horses last time out, Goliath Hanover took a step up to the \$20,000 overnight fast-class pace and won with aplomb, sweeping wide off cover and pacing away to a new lifetime best of 1:49 under the direction of Matt Kakaley. The victorious Betting Line gelding has won \$29,500 during his four-race win skein, and his new account for owner P T Stable and trainer Darren Taneyhill already has \$10,000 of that.

The horses in Pocono’s fourth race wore a white ribbon in their manes to honor those horses who lost life in a fire at Saratoga Harness earlier this week.

Besides their stakes quadruple, Wrenn/Burke (the latter top trainer at PcD) also won an overnight race to each visit Victory Lane five times. The Pelling/Beckwith win with Gracious was part of a double for both horsemen.

The highest-level claimers at Pocono will be spotlighted during today’s 5 p.m. twilight card; 2-year-olds will also be making early pari-mutuel starts in other contests. Free Pocono program pages are or will be available at [www.phha.org](http://www.phha.org).

# Bingo Night impressive in her 2026 Ontario Sires Stakes debut

**Bingo Night** and **Th Trix R Forkids** each recorded lifetime-best victories winning their respective \$90,000 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series leg 2 divisions on Saturday (June 20) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

In the first division (race 4), favored **Bingo Night** won her 2026 OSS debut in convincing fashion, posting a four-length victory over second choice **Blue Jean Gal** in a lifetime best 1:52.1 mile that was just one-fifth-of-a-second off the all-time OSS record for her age, gender, and gait.

Tyler Jones eased **Bingo Night** into third off the gate from post 6 in the eight-horse field as **HP Crystaline** led the fillies through a :26.4 opening quarter. Jones began making his move as the field came out of the first turn and **Bingo Night** was on top before the :56.2 half. She cruised from there through the three-quarters in 1:24.4. She came home in :27.2 to seal the victory, increase her lifetime bankroll to \$470,669 and improve her record to 6-3-3 in 15 starts.

**Lo And Behold** (Louis-Philippe Roy) was third, **M E Laurel** (Mark MacDonald) was fourth, and **Barbara May** (Doug McNair) grabbed the final check.

**Bingo Night** paid \$3.80.

Jones drove **Bingo Night** to victory for his father/trainer/co-owner/co-breeder **Dustin Jones**, who shares the breeding credit on the filly with co-owner **Herbert Horses Inc.** **Bingo Night**, a daughter of **Green Manalishi S** out of **Cant Stop Tammi** is also owned by **Sjoebloom Racing Inc.**

In the winner's circle, Tyler told Woodbine broadcaster **John Rallis** that **Bingo Night** was eased into her 3-year-old year after a long

2-year-old campaign in which she had a record of 5-3-3 in 12 starts, winning two Gold legs and the **\$300,000 Super Final**.

"The original plan for the year was to start her off slowly because she had such a big year last year, raced until November, raced in the Breeders Crown, when, if it wasn't at Mohawk, we probably would have never done it," Tyler said. "So, we gave her a little extra time, and then my dad, credit to him and credit to the owners, stuck by his game plan. He wanted three qualifiers and gave her three nice, easy qualifiers, and two good starts in the overnights. And last week I thought she was going to race a lot better than that, but she kind of got interfered with just a little bit at top of the lane, and didn't get a check, but I knew she raced better than the week before, so I knew she was ready to go tonight."

Tyler added that the trotter has a jam-packed stakes schedule from this point forward.

Prior to Saturday, in her only other 2026 pari-mutuel starts, Bingo Night was seventh and fifth, respectively, in a pair of overnights at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

As for Blue Jean Gal and HP Crystalline, they each won \$90,000 **Leg 1 OSS Gold Series events** on May 24 at Woodbine Mohawk Park with Bingo Night absent.

Blue Jean Gal also won the \$75,000 OSS Grassroots final at 2.

In the second Gold division on Saturday, 2-1 second choice Th Trix R Forkids was sent to the front out of post 9 by driver James MacDonald, led the field through fractions of :27.3, :57, and 1:25.2, and held off 4-5 favorite Flowing Tribute (Bob McClure) by 1¼ lengths in a career best 1:53.

Cher Hill (Doug McNair) was third, Social Wizard (Tyler Borth) finished fourth, and Satu Wania (Trevor Henry) was sixth-placed-fifth when Ronda May K made a break in deep stretch.

It was MacDonald's first-time driving Th Trix R Forkids, who is trained by Murray Brethour.

"[Th Trix R Forkids] is just a gem to drive," MacDonald told Rallis. "I kind of got that vibe racing against her and Murray texted me and said she was beautiful and then [her previous driver] Doug [McNair] said the same thing, that she is a Cadillac to drive. They couldn't be more right."

The victory improved Th Trix R Forkids to 5-1-1 in 10 career starts and pushed her bankroll over \$100,000 to exactly \$129,723 for owner/co-breeder Glenn Bechtel of Stanhope, PEI, who shares the breeding credit on the daughter of Muscle

Mass out of One Trix Pony with Tara Hills Stud of Port Perry, ON.

Th Trix R Forkids was third in her OSS debut on May 24 at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Lightly raced at 2, Th Trix R Forkids won two of her five starts, including the \$45,400 final of the Harvest Series in November.



### Ygritte, 'Toby' pop in Exit 16W at Big M

**Ygritte** and **Toby Ornot Toby** scored in the Friday night (June 19) co-features at The Meadowlands, taking their respective \$32,500 divisions of the Exit 16W Pop Up Series finals for 3- and 4-year-olds of each gait.

In the split for trotters, Ygritte stayed perfect in five seasonal tries for trainer Marcus Melander, and his brother, Mattias, who guided the 3-year-old daughter of Gimpanzee—Etta Am S to a 1:53.3 score.

Sitting fourth early as longshot Dollar Draft hit the quarter in :29 and half in :57, Mattias moved Ygritte off the rail just after the half-mile marker. She moved with authority toward the leader first-over, towing slight even-money favorite It Could Be Worse

with her, as Dollar Draft clung tenuously to the top at three-quarters in 1:25.1.

Ygritte collared Dollar Draft with an eighth to go, but soon thereafter, It Could Be Worse tipped off that one's cover with what appeared to be a full head of steam, only to go off-stride with a little more than a 16th to go, which permitted Ygritte to go on to an easy three-quarter-length win over a fast-closing Lucchese. Dollar Draft held third.

"It wasn't a great trip," said Mattias. "She had to do a lot of work by herself. She's just a great filly."

A Hambletonian Oaks eligible, Ygritte, who only had one start during 2025, paid \$4.20 to win as the even-money second choice in the betting.

Toby Ornot Toby won the division for pacers after grinding his foes down first-over for the final half-mile on the way to a 1:51.3 score for trainer Scott DiDomenico and driver Tim Tetrick.

Off a 1:52 win a week ago, Rocknacious went to the gate as the 6-5 favorite from the rail, and after watching Battlin Bob take the field of seven past the quarter in :27.4, Jason Bartlett moved the chalk to the top and led at the half in :56.2.

Rocknacious was rolling along down the backside, but Toby Ornot Toby was now on the scene after vacating the rail from fourth with a half-mile to go, and was getting uncomfortably close to the leader as three-quarters went in 1:24.3.

"Toby" continued to gain on Rocknacious, taking the top with an eighth to go on the way to a 1½-length score, his third victory in 13 lifetime tries.

"This colt, he was really good [tonight] after being off a month before last week," said Tetrick. "Anybody who watched him last week could see he had some sneaky late pace. Scotty and the crew had him ready. He's an above average colt."

## Upgrade doubles up in Grassroots; Perfect night for McNair

**Upgrade** doubled up in the Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots Series as Woodbine Mohawk Park played host to the second leg for 3-year-old trotting fillies on an eventful Friday (June 19) card that featured Canada's first 2-year-old pari-mutuel race winner amid a perfect five-win night for driver Doug McNair and a training triple for Kyle Fellows.

Following up on a victory in the May 17 opening leg of the Grassroots at Flamboro Downs, driver Todd Ratchford looped the Matt Bax trainee Upgrade to the lead after a :28.1 quarter and the even-money favorite cruised through middle splits of :58.4 and 1:27.4 en route to the 2¼-length triumph in a new lifetime mark of 1:56 flat. Winless in eight starts as a 2-year-old, the Green Manalishi S—Uptown Classic filly is now three-for-10 this year for owners Al Libfeld of Pickering, ON, and Brad Grant of Milton, ON. Arkona Seelster (Tyler Borth) advanced first-over to finish second just ahead of the closing HP Imagine (James MacDonald).

**Bella Chica**, a Prospect Series champion as a 2-year-old and runner-up to Upgrade in this year's Grassroots opening leg, won the fastest of the three \$25,000 Grassroots divisions in round 2 as the even-money second choice retook command down the backstretch then opened up an insurmountable lead en route to establishing a new lifetime mark of 1:55.1 with Bob McClure in tow. The Looklikeeachpndale—Wheely Tricky filly is a homebred for trainer Corrie German and Brenda German of Clinton, ON. Longshots Rare Legacy (Borth) and Finley (Scott Coulter) rounded out the top three finish order.

The other Grassroots division was won by 6-5 favorite **Canukepasecret** (Muscle Mass—More Magic), who made up for a miscue in the opening leg with a four-length romp in a new mark of 1:56 for driver Travis Cullen, trainer Jeff Williams, and owners Mardon Stables of Loretto, ON, Tyrone Valley Farm of Bowmanville, ON, and Hudson Standardbred Stable of Hudson, QC. Press On Ballykeel (Borth) inherited second over a rough-gaited Kenogami Bellini (MacDonald).

McNair enjoyed a perfect night in sulky, winning all five of his drives. He won the first four races on the card then had to wait until the 12th race finale for his last drive. The Kyle Fellows-trained Fan Hanover starter **Easy Station** made it worth the wait, winning in a career-best 1:50.1 by 2¼ lengths over sophomore filly stablemate Pownal Bay Bobbi after a pair of their rookie roommates made successful debuts.

The Fellows-trained **Three Six Zero** became Canada's first 2-year-old winner of the season in pari-mutuel racing action

with a 1:58.4 wire-to-wire score in the third race, a \$20,000 freshman colt trot. McNair guided Three Six Zero to the top in the first turn, hitting the quarter in :29.2, then the half in :59.1, and three-quarters in 1:29.4. Arm N Hammer (McClure) chased inside as Three Six Zero drifted off the pylons in the stretch but steered clear approaching the wire with the pocket-pursuer finishing two lengths behind.

Following a successful June 12 qualifier at Mohawk, Three Six Zero won at first asking for owners Yolanda Fellows of Rockwood, ON, Blair Corbeil of Leduc, AB, Windermere Stable of New York City, NY, and Hopkins Porter of Chesley, ON. A full brother to multiple Grassroots winner Hot Country, the Muscle Mass—Feel Invincible As colt was a \$69,444 yearling purchase from the Lexington Selected Sale. He was bred by Tara Hills Stud of Port Perry, ON, Glenn Bechtel of Kingston, ON, and Jon Brinkerhoff of Hilliard, OH.

Fellows also debuted the Sweet Lou—Beach Work filly **Im Sweet On Lou**, a 1:54.1 winner in the following race for 2-year-old pacing fillies.

McNair also won the opener with the 3-year-old pacing filly **Twin B Fierce**, trained by his father Gregg, taking a new lifetime mark of 1:52.3. The hot-handed reinsman completed a sweep of the early Daily Double with pacing mare **Laneside Incontrol** opening a Pop-Up Series with a 1:51.4 victory for trainer Murray Brethour.

The other \$20,000 Pop-Up division went to **Sensationalize A**, winning her second start in North America in 1:51 for Travis and Jodie Cullen.

That conditioned series is for pacing fillies and mares that were starters for a purse of \$12,000 or less in their last four starts (winners over \$50,000 in 2026 are not eligible).

## Oak Grove unveils new format for upcoming KYSS series

A marathon race week approaches at Oak Grove Racing, Gaming & Hotel this Monday (June 22) through Wednesday (June 24) with Kentucky Sire Stakes (KYSS) finals for 4-year-olds as well as the start of KYSS series for 2- and 3-year-olds, which will be contested under a new and exciting format.

Monday's card features four \$150,000 KYSS finals for 4-year-olds and the opening round of KYSS action for pacing 2-year-olds within the 15-race card. Oak Grove will host "Tuesday at the

Trots” the following day (June 23) with 16 trotting events scheduled before wrapping the week on Wednesday (June 24) with a program featuring the opening round of KYSS for pacing 3-year-olds. First-race post time each day will be 1:10 p.m. (CDT).

For 2026, the 2- and 3-year-old KYSS series at Oak Grove will be conducted in tiered events. Each series for 2- and 3-year-olds will have three events total with the top performers eligible to race for increased purses through the series. Following the \$40,000 opening preliminary this week, the top finishers (i.e., the first- through fourth-place finishers) will be eligible to race in the second event – the week of July 6 – for a \$60,000 purse while the remaining participants and any other new entrants to the series can compete in divisions for \$40,000. The top eight money earners across the two events will then be eligible to compete in an \$80,000 event on closing week – the week of July 13 – while the remaining participants can enter into a \$50,000 race. Any eligible horses that skip the first two events of the KYSS series will have the potential to race in Kentucky-bred maiden races for a \$30,000 purse if at least six horses enter and at the discretion of the race secretary. Every race through this tiered series will also have post positions determined by an open draw.

Ahead of the cavalcade of Kentucky-bred races this week, Oak Grove is also revamping the wagering menu. The 15-race card on Monday will feature three \$1 Pick-4s with sequences starting in race 1, race 5, and race 12. The 20-cent Pick-5 has been moved later in the card to start in race 9, and all multi-race wagers at Oak Grove feature a takeout of just 15 per cent. The “Tuesday at the Trots” card features a similar menu with \$1 Pick-4s starting in race 1, race 5, and race 13 and the 20-cent Pick-5 starting in race 9.

The opening round of KYSS for 2- and 3-year-olds helps to bring the curtain down on the 2026 meeting at Oak Grove, which has 10 race days remaining. Monday’s card features nearly \$1 million in purses with 107 horses in competition while the “Tuesday at the Trots” program has over \$600,000 in purses on offer with 116 horses entered. Oak Grove hosts live harness racing on Monday (June 29) and Tuesday (June 30) before the next round of KYSS gets underway with another three-day-race week starting on Monday (July 6).
