So, the question remains: When and where will the top three sophomore male pacers face off again?

Obviously, they all plan to go to the Breeders Crown at Scioto, but that's three months away. What about now?

That magic moment could materialize at The Meadowlands, two weeks from Saturday, in the Grade 2 \$300,000 (est.) Cane Pace on Aug. 8 on Hambletonian Day.

A lot would have to happen to bring about that heavyweight rematch, but longer shots have come in.

Odds On Mr Mamba.

Trainer/co-owner Andrew Harris keeps his cards close to the vest when it comes to his plans for the remainder of the season for Brandon Blvd, but one thing he did confirm was that he and co-owners Bill Pollock and Bruce Areman, that comprise Punisher 11 Stable LLC, have the Cane Pace on their colt's dance card.

"It is race to race, but at the same time, I haven't changed my plan yet," Harris said. "My plan's been the same, and I had a conversation with Bill and Bruce the day after his race [in the Meadowlands Pace], and I talked about staying on the same plan that I had going into the race, and everybody was in agreement. So, as of right now, we have not changed the plan. There's one race that's a maybe that we didn't originally have on the plan that we could end up going to, but as of right now, we're not changing any plans."

Brandon Blvd, a son of Downbytheseaside—Alexis Faith, last raced on July 11 when he won the \$810,000 Grade 1 Meadowlands Pace by a head over Al Papi.

"He showed how much heart he's got because he looked like he was beat at the three-quarter pole, and then he just battled the whole way down the lane," Harris said of Brandon Blvd's Pace victory.

Brandon Blvd is eligible to the Tompkins-Geers at The Meadowlands on Saturday (Aug. 1) if they wanted a tightener over the track before the Cane, and he is the only one of the

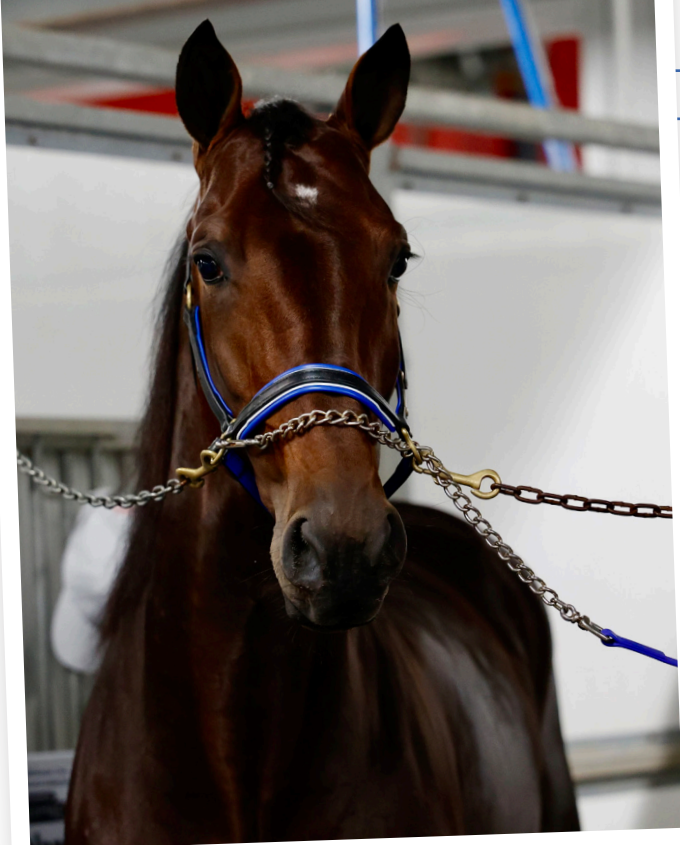

big three eligible to the second leg of the Pacing Triple Crown.

Beau Jangles last raced on June 27 in an Ontario Sires Stakes Gold event where he finished fifth. Since that time, the defending U.S. and Canadian Horse of the Year, had been battling a lung infection, but according to his co-owner Adam Ainspan, plans to qualify today (July 24) at his home track, Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"A lot depends on how he comes back," Ainspan said. "He is scheduled to qualify on [July 24] and race at Grand River [in an OSS Gold event on] Aug. 3. After that he has several opportunities in the States, either staked or an invitational.

"If 'Beau' seems well on Aug. 3, I would consider supplementing him to the Cane."

Ainspan and his wife, Mary Beth Roberts, comprise Graham Grace Stables LLC, who own the Dr. Ian Moore-trained Beau Jangles with partners Kiwi Stables LLC, and Bolton Stables.

Dana Parham's Odds On Racing owns Odds On Mr Mamba, the winner of the \$1 million (CDN) North America Cup over Brandon Blvd and Beau Jangles, who finished second and third, respectively. Odds On Mr Mamba, trained by Melanie Wrenn, competed in an Indiana Sires Stakes event on June 26 where he finished third.

"I think when you race at this level, at least in my mind, I want to have the best product, and we weren't going to have that for the Meadowlands Pace," Parham said of Odds On Mr Mamba. "He came out of the North America Cup, and lost a little bit of weight. He bled a little in his next start where he finished third and we just didn't think that we were going to put the best product on the racetrack [for the Pace]."

Odds On Mr Mamba, bred by Parham's Odds On Nourrir, last competed on July 18 in an elimination for the Grade 1 Adios, where he finished first by a neck over Frantic Hanover in 1:49.3.

The son of Odds On Equuleus—Honky Tonk Woman has post 3 for Saturday's (July 25) \$420,500 Adios final at The Meadows and is the 3-1 second choice on the morning line. Al Papi, winner of the other Adios elimination, is the 5-2 morning-line favorite from post 4.

Just like Ainspan, Parham is considering supplementing to the Cane.

"I have the Cane on his schedule," Parham said. "So, should we do well in this next race, and he comes out good, I certainly would like him to race at The Meadowlands. We also have the Tompkins-Geers a week before."

Whether or not Beau Jangles, Brandon Blvd, and Odds On Mr Mamba tangle in August at The Meadowlands or later in the year, Harris said he thinks there's another horse in their division that should be part of the discussion.

"I think it's kind of unfair to leave Al Papi out of the conversation," Harris said. "He's definitely a part of it. He makes his presence felt in every race he's in."

No more Chicago area racing

The horse and buggy era has ended in the Chicago metropolitan area.

This year, for the first time since 1945, there will be no pari-mutuel harness racing in the area.

And Chicagoland thoroughbred racing apparently hit the finish line for the last time when the final race at bankrupt Hawthorne Race Course was run on July 19, ending a continuous run for the thoroughbreds dating back to 1922 at the southwest suburban Stickney location.

The only bidder, a Delaware-based company named Allimac 23 LLC, purchased the 119-acre property earlier this month for \$90 million with the intention of tearing it down and developing the land for commercial purposes.

Harness racing made its Hawthorne debut in 1970 – 24 years after the state's inaugural pari-mutuel meeting at Maywood Park in 1946 – but since then there have been interludes with no racing.

This year, all 14 of the harness programs under the auspices of Hawthorne's Suburban Downs subsidiary scheduled for January and February, were canceled as a consequence of the track's bounced checks and rapidly escalating financial dilemma.

Now, because of the sale to Allimac, the meet scheduled for Nov. 6-Dec. 27 will not be held.

Thoroughbred racing began on April 19 and was scheduled to run through Nov. 1. Due to a lack of money to fund the purses, racing shriveled to Sunday only. But the thoroughbred horsemen haven't been paid for the July 5, 12, and 19 programs and no future programs have been scheduled.

All told Hawthorne's creditors number approximately 250 and the total amount owed by the Carey-family is estimated to be \$138 million.

That’s \$48 million more than Allimac paid for the property.

Therefore, Judge Timothy Barnes scheduled a hearing today (July 24) in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for Northern Illinois to determine how the overdue purse funds will be paid, the pecking order of the creditors and the amounts they’ll receive.

Also to be finalized is the fate of 337 adult workers, their 147 children and approximately 447 thoroughbreds in the stable area.

Earlier in the week, Judge Barnes decided to allow the backstretch to stay open through Monday (Aug. 31) to give the workers, children, and horses time to relocate.

“There are a number of moving parts here and I’m trying to stop them from moving,” Judge Barnes said. “I would be very hesitant to use the power of this court to dispossess people.”

The judge emphasized that he has a legal and constitutional obligation to consider “health and the public welfare” in addition to financial matters.

In contrast, Hawthorne attorney Barry Chatz took a calloused approach to the plight of members of the Illinois Thoroughbred Horsemen’s Association. “Take your horses and go!” he told them at the day-long hearing earlier in the week.

Hawthorne president Tim Carey has issued a conciliatory statement, thanking those who have worked and competed at the track during its 117 years of family ownership.

“The outcome of the bidding process is not what we wanted, nor is it what this industry deserves,” he said. “Nevertheless, we

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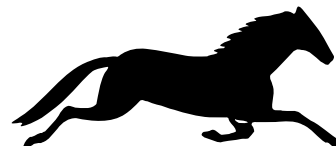

are continuing to actively explore options to ease this transition that will affect so many people.

“To the horsemen, bettors, and our employees, please know that we never gave up and, in fact, continue to seek a path forward for Illinois racing.”

Hawthorne was one of America’s oldest racetracks. It was opened by its builder, Edward Corrigan, on May 20, 1891 and he conducted racing there until 1905 when racing was banned in Chicago.

He sold the property to Thomas Carey in 1909 and after a few unsuccessful attempts to revive racing, Carey was successful when the ban was lifted in 1922.

Although Thomas’ great grandson, Tim Carey, has often referred to the family’s unwavering 117-year commitment to racing, the track, in fact, was run by the Chicago Business Men’s Racing Association under a lease arrangement from 1924 through 1945.

Since Arlington International Racecourse’s owner Churchill Downs, Inc. terminated racing at the palatial thoroughbred track in 2021 to kill gambling competition for the nearby Rivers Casino that it holds a 62 per cent interest in, Hawthorne has been the only racetrack in Chicagoland.

In harness racing, dual-purpose Hawthorne moved into the void after collaborating with Arlington to put Maywood and Balmoral Park out of business following their 2015 meetings. Balmoral’s American-National series and Maywood’s Windy City Pace and Galt Trot had lured some of North America’s leading harness horses annually but the move to Hawthorne meant the end of Chicago area races of national importance.

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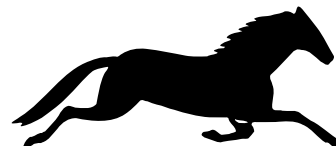

at Pocono Downs on Tuesday (July 21), Sears steered his way back into the winner's circle with a couldn't-lose 2-year-old colt named Celebrity Hunter, who won by a margin of 12 lengths.

The next morning at Pocono, Sears qualified to win a 2-year-old filly he co-owns named Papi's Bride. By Papi Rob Hanover, Papi's Bride is out of the standout mare Native Bride – who had been owned in her racing days by Sears father, Jay.

The natural question then raised through these events is: Does this mark the beginning of a potential full-fledged return to driving for Sears? At this juncture the answer unfortunately is probably not.

I reached out to Sears, but was unable to connect with him before deadline. But, sporadic quotes from him over the past year have been consistent in not yet indicating a desire to make a formal comeback. In a DRF Harness column this week by Derick Giwner, the quote that maybe sums it up best is Sears stating on Tuesday, "I was just having a little fun."

As unlikely as it seems now, everyone in this sport loves a good comeback story – and what better story than to think what a Sears return would look like.

Even if Sears returned on a limited basis, it would immediately have an impact on Grand Circuit driver designations. Leading up to and including Sears' last year of racing in 2023, don't forget that Sears was getting top call for horses from Marcus Melander. That includes world champion Gimpanzee throughout 2020, 2-year-olds of 2021 Joviality and Temporal Hanover while driving those two horses again at age 3 in 2022, in addition to Kilmister as a 2-year-old that same year in the Peter Haughton.

At present, driver go-tos for Melander have become Dexter Dunn and Scott Zeron, but having Sears even as a time-to-time

possibility would change the driver calculus. Not only for the Melander barn, but for any trainer of stakes-quality stock.

Sears is now 58 years old, but it doesn't seem like it. The math adds up, but I still see him as the same guy from the 2000s decade at The Meadowlands. He was still as good as anyone when driving on a reduced schedule three years ago. So, aside from maybe having to shake some initial rust off in real high-speed race scenarios, I'd think he would be as capable as ever.

It is hard to believe based on how time flies, but you have to go all the way back to 2008 for Sears' highest earning year driving. That year, he earned purses of more than \$16 million, including horses such as a 2-year-old you may have heard of named Muscle Hill and a who's who of other top horses such as Arch Madness, Mister Big, as well as multiple stakes wins with the aforementioned filly, Native Bride.

The statistics alone don't tell a full story since that time. Sears' last season over \$10 million came in 2013, but that's almost entirely a function of Sears' own choices to drive less frequently. At no point between then and now was he ever regarded as anything other than one of the most premium drivers.

Putting all of the "what-if's" aside, the speculation runs into reality where Sears is yet to indicate any of the above. The drives last week were attributed simply to a trainer relationship with Hunter Oakes as well as interest in one of his own horses and, at least for now, that's the extent of it.

Harness racing is more interesting with Sears in it. And If nothing else, another week of Sears racing will help to keep the speculation alive.

I don't know if anyone knows how long it will last for – potentially not even Sears himself – but the show will continue again next week at Pocono. That's where Sears is listed on two more drives for Hunter Oakes, including the career debut for Papi's Bride. Harness racing is more interesting with Sears in it. And If nothing else, another week of Sears racing will help to keep the speculation alive.

Meta data from Jason Libby keeps his Lady Speaker co-owners in the loop

When Jason Libby added veteran pacer Lady Speaker to his racing roster in late June, he knew he was getting a reliable competitor with a proven track record on the grassroots circuit.

What he didn't know was that he'd soon be training the fastest older pacing mare in the history of Dresden Raceway.

"When Nathan [Bain, Dresden track announcer] said it was a track record, it really surprised me," said Libby, reflecting on the landmark July 12 result. "And the way she did it — she left from the 7-hole, landed in the 4-hole, and then popped first up and just kept coming — I was very impressed."

Lady Speaker's final time of 1:54.4, capped by a personal-best :27.4 final quarter, toppled the three-week-old record of Jewels Diamondeyes by three-fifths-of-a-second.

For Libby, who had not yet acquired Lady Speaker when the previous mark was set (June 21), the remarkable feat with driver Austin Sorrie in tow reinforced everything he and his fellow owners had admired from afar.

"Coming into the race she was really good, she was brave," Libby said. "Paul MacKenzie drove her first two starts and just loved her. Going into this third one with Austin, I thought from the 7-hole that we'd have to hope for some crazy fractions and then clean up the shrapnel, but he [Sorrie] did it on his own and she was awesome."

"All she's done is make money. She was a check-getter, and she's been exactly that so far."

Sorrie's deft driving set a high bar moving forward — perhaps a little too high.

"A new lifetime mark and a track record for your first time sitting behind her? I don't know where you go from here," Libby said with a laugh.

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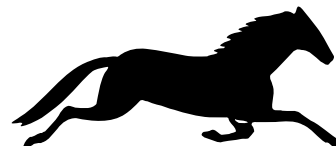

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“[Meta glasses are] the best tool for a trainer to interact with an owner. [Co-owner] Ronnie, for example, is in P.E.I., so I’ll shoot a quick 30-second video of Lady Speaker jogging... I’ll give a little rundown, like ‘Oh, we’re at the quarter in 36 seconds; she’s on the right line a little bit.’ Before, a trainer used to call the owner to say if a horse was good or bad or whatever. Now, twice a week, they’re getting videos of their horse training down.”

Lady Speaker now joins Dreamfair Vogel (Elmira Raceway) and To Helen Back (Kawartha Downs) on Libby’s list of trainees to rewrite the record books.

“‘Vogel,’ that’ll never get beat because there’s no Elmira anymore,” he said. “To Helen Back was beat a while back, but those were two very special horses. They were young 2-year-olds and 3-year-olds, so this one with Lady Speaker was different being my first with an aged mare.”

The pride Libby feels from seeing the 6-year-old daughter of Artspeak—Lady Mach in action is not exclusive to him.

Each member of Lady Speaker’s hands-on ownership group, made up of Ronnie MacLean, Tim Flynn, Doug Dunbar, and Libby, shares that same pride, while contributing to her success in their own unique way.

"Ronnie used to train horses, he's like the bloodhound," Libby said. "He's the one who does all the scouting on onGait, he sniffs everything out. Then we have Tim, a retired school teacher. He's our money guy. Then myself, who does the training, and Doug, our super senior. He's 80, and he comes to the farm to help out, clean stalls, and walk horses.

"Between the four of us, we have everything we need. It's not a 'sit back and watch' type of dynamic. We all have something to do."

In a sport where familiarity and routine are key, an abrupt change in environment is risky.

Fortunately for Libby and Co., their cohesive approach, coupled with the foundation built by her previous connections, helped ease Lady Speaker's transition after spending five years with trainer Jamie Doig.

"I've had horses that are homesick, but she hasn't really changed since we claimed her," Libby said. "She was a good-looking horse and was well taken care of. Jamie's a stand-up individual in the horse business, so what you see is what you get.

"She's a nice, tough old mare. She's a lovely horse to be around and she's got a paddock buddy [Joyce] that she goes out with for an hour or so in the morning. We got quite fortunate that all the stars aligned, and Ronnie's homework paid off."

A unique part of the endeavor's success is that each member of the quartet has been able to see Lady Speaker's progress through Libby's eyes – literally.

The Dorchester, ON-based conditioner upgraded his training toolkit with what he anointed the "greatest invention ever for a horse trainer," Meta Glasses.

The spectacles that record video and audio from a first-person perspective have added an immersive element to the ownership experience.

"It's the best tool for a trainer to interact with an owner," Libby said. "Ronnie, for example, is in P.E.I., so I'll shoot a quick 30-second video of Lady Speaker jogging or when I turn her out with her paddock buddy.

"I'll give a little rundown, like 'Oh, we're at the quarter in 36 seconds; she's on the right line a little bit.' Before, a trainer used to call the owner to say if a horse was good or bad or whatever. Now, twice a week, they're getting videos of their horse training down."

Call it an effective value proposition for Libby's services.

"I use that to get everybody involved," he said. "I figure if they're going to spend some money, they might as well get a little bit extra, instead of just weekly simulcast feeds."

Going the extra mile, as Libby noted, is all part of a life in the horse business.

Between taking training videos, watching simulcast feeds and race replays on YouTube, and studying race lines on TrackIt, the scouting process is a never-ending, yet natural, pursuit.

“The homework part is everyday life; that’s our life,” Libby said. “You see a horse, it’s something that catches your eye. ‘Fifth race number seven, who’s that?’ Just like Lady Speaker, I watched the replays and saw she was good-gaited, can win any style – I’ve seen her on the front end, first up, three wide, she was just a very good racehorse.

“Looking for horses is part of our DNA; it’s in our blood. It’s not a chore, it’s not a big deal, it’s not a job – it’s just what we do.”

A fresh catch is never too far out of sight for Libby.

“I’ll go fishing in Lake Ontario and I’ve got either my phone or my iPad propped up with the races going,” he said. “You got the CN Tower off in the distance and [track announcer] Gary Guy’s voice in the background.”

With racing always within reach, it’s no surprise to see Lady Speaker emerge as the latest beneficiary of Libby’s expert horsemanship.

Backed by MacLean, Flynn, and Dunbar, the trainer with three decades of service under his belt will continue to express his gratitude as only he knows how.

“The more information I can give them about their horse, the better,” Libby said. “It’s what I provide as far as my training bill. You get the horse looked after, plus you get lots of documentation in videos, texts, and pictures.

“I appreciate their investment with me, and in return, I try to give them as much knowledge, fun, and an experience of their own.”

Diva Ek back for revenge in MGM Yonkers International Trot

Along the lines of “if at first you don’t succeed, try, try again” is Diva Ek. The runner-up in the 2025 MGM Yonkers International Trot has accepted an invitation to this year’s Grade 1 event on Sept. 12 at MGM Yonkers Raceway.

Representing Italy, Diva Ek was hardly at fault when finishing second behind Lexus Kody in the \$1,000,000 race last year. She had to start from the difficult outside post 8 in the field of 10 and was able to close from last – including making up nearly seven lengths in the final quarter-mile – to lose by just a half-length.

“Last year was an amazing race and she loves to race like that [from behind],” said Alessandro Gocciadoro, who drives/trains for

owners Antonio Nucera and Effebi Srl. “Even in her last Grade 1 win she raced the same, with a super final burst.”

Since her 2025 appearance in the United States, Diva Ek returned to Europe and has won three of six starts, including capturing the **Group 1 Finlandia Ajo** in May. She made the Elitlopp final but finished sixth behind Allegiant in her **world record mile**.

Just this past Sunday (July 19), Diva Ek went to the front in the **St. Michael Ajo Trot** in Finland and battled with Don Fanucci Zet early before succumbing in the stretch to Swedish-bred Kuiper at the mile distance (1,609 meters).

“Diva Ek was amazing yesterday,” Gocciadoro said. “The track was very heavy. It was a cold and rainy day. With that heavy track, she was a little bit tired the last 100 meters, but we were very happy with her performance. She always races on a high level.”

Diva Ek has 23 wins in 47 career starts and earnings of just under \$800K (USD). The 7-year-old has one more race in Östersund (Sweden) on Aug. 8 before shipping to the United States for the MGM Yonkers International Trot.

Gocciadoro, who won the 2023 MGM Yonkers International Trot with Vivid Wise As, appreciates the race and its worldwide appeal.

“The International Trot is such an amazing experience that we love to participate in it every year,” he said. “The organization is fantastic and it is a beautiful atmosphere.”

Diva Ek joins Swedish-bred Bourbonista in the lineup for the MGM Yonkers International Trot. More invitations will be extended soon to complete the 10-horse field. The race will be the focal point of a stellar card on Sept. 12 that starts at 11:50 a.m. (EDT) and includes the \$2.4 million New York Sire Stakes finals for 2- and 3-year-olds, as well as a pair of \$200,000 invitationals: Bob Miecuna Trot and Aria Pace.

MGM Yonkers Raceway is currently operating on a Monday through Friday racing schedule with post time at 6:45 p.m. (EDT).





Owners pumped about Kindergarten starter Perfect Body

Randy Beach and his partners went to the Standardbred Horse Sale in Harrisburg, PA, this past fall with their sights set on one horse – Perfect Body. When the group registered the winning bid at \$20,000, they were thrilled.

Now, after watching the daughter of Perfect Sting—Sweet Body get her career off to a strong start, including a 1:51.4 win last week in the second round of the New Jersey Sire Stakes Platinum Series for 2-year-old filly pacers, that feeling certainly hasn't changed.

"We're so pumped," said Beach, a New Jersey resident who shares ownership of Perfect Body with Craig Smith, Charles "Mike" Rowe and Carl Austin, Jr. "I've been walking on air after the New Jersey Sire Stakes win last week. It's been a fun week and a great start

to her campaign. [Trainer] Chris Choate has done an amazing job getting her to this point. We're fortunate to have her and hope she can build on the early success and keep the party going this season."

Tonight (July 24), Perfect Body will get the opportunity to keep the good times rolling. She will compete in the first of two \$25,000 Kindergarten Classic Series divisions for freshman filly pacers at The Meadowlands, where she is the 7-5 morning-line favorite. She will leave from post 3 with Brett Beckwith in the sulky.

Last week, Perfect Body got away fifth in a field of 10, and Beckwith worked out a second-over trip from the half-mile point before coming home in :27 to get the win by three-quarters-of-a-length despite drifting a bit in the stretch. In her previous start – her career debut in the first round of the NJSS Platinum – she came home in :26.2 and finished third. None of her rivals paced faster last quarters than her in either race.

"I think she shows that she's still green when you watch her race," Beach said. "But when each of those races ends with a :26 or :27, it makes you believe she hasn't tapped her full potential yet. She's got some size to her, and it takes a little to get her rolling, but she seems to carry her speed well.

"We've been encouraged, really from her first qualifier at Gaitway [Farm, on June 17]. She ended up on the lead, which wasn't the plan, but she looked great. There were horses coming at her late in the mile, but you could see her wake up and start pulling away again at the finish. To me, it was a great sign that she had that kind of fight. She's learning as she goes, and she hasn't disappointed us yet."

Beach and his partners targeted Perfect Body for several reasons, including the success they had last year with Home Grown Filly Pace winner PA Perfect, another daughter of Perfect Sting. Beach liked Perfect Body's yearling video and her pedigree, particularly that the filly's Grand Circuit-winning half-sister Ambushed was by Always B Miki, who also is the father of Perfect Sting. He also wanted a horse that would race in New Jersey.

"Perfect Body was the primary target that we had circled [for the Harrisburg sale]," Beach said. "I had my crosshairs trained on her, but it takes a village, right? I greatly value the opinions of Chris Choate and Mike Rowe; they looked at her at the sale and felt that she passed the eye test with flying colors. We expected her to have plenty of interest, so we were elated when the gavel dropped at what we felt was a very reasonable 20 [thousand dollars]."

Beach grew up going to the races with his parents and a grandmother, and his parents eventually owned horses in the early 1990s. Beach got started as an owner himself three years ago.

"I've always loved the sport, and wanted to get back into it," Beach said. "We're smaller owners, and it seems like we're starting to hit on some of the right ones now. It's a great [ownership] group, and that makes it a lot of fun."

"It's nice being able to go into these races and feel that you're a contender versus being 15-1, where maybe you can make some noise but need a perfect storm to make it happen. You hope you can find a horse that ends up becoming a difference maker. This one feels like a special horse. We're pretty thrilled to be in this position."

The Meadowlands will host a total of eight Kindergarten divisions for 2-year-old pacers and trotters. This is the second leg of the series, which consists of five preliminary rounds before the finals and consolations on Oct. 31. The first leg of the series, which was scheduled for July 3, was canceled because of extreme heat.

Chapter Geo J, AI win in NYSS action at Yonkers

Chapter Geo J and **AI**, two colts by Chapter Seven, won the pair of \$84,000 New York Sire Stakes divisions for 3-year-old trotting colts that took place on Thursday (July 23) evening at MGM Yonkers Raceway.

Driven by Jason Bartlett in the first split, Chapter Geo J led to the quarter in :28.1 and the half in :57.2, then got separation on the rest of the pack as he trotted towards three-quarters in 1:25.4. From there, Chapter Geo J used a :28.4 final quarter to slam the door on a 1:54.3 victory, defeating a first-over Seven Grand (Tyler Buter) by 6¼ lengths. Who's Eyes Blues (Yannick Gingras) tired from the pocket but held third.

Noel Daley trains Chapter Geo J for owner Ken Jacobs. Bred by Lester Beechy, Chapter Geo J now has three wins, five seconds, and a third from 12 starts, has earned \$175,544 and paid \$3.22 to win as the favorite. He led a \$9.02 exacta and a \$20.22 trifecta.

In the other section AI (Gingras) overcame the outside post 6 with little issue and was in front of his five foes well prior to the :28.4 quarter. AI then reached the half in :57.4 before Read The Room (Ake Svanstedt) pulled out of the pocket on the third turn and gave cover to favored Silverstein (Matt Kakaley). Read The Room took the lead on the rim before the 1:25.2 three-quarters, but never could clear AI, and AI battled back on the inside in the stretch to defeat Read The Room by a half-length in 1:54.3. Silverstein wound up third.

Last year's New York Sire Stakes champion for this group, AI was sent out by Ron Burke for owners Burke Racing Stable LLC, Hatfield Stables, Knox Services Inc, and Weaver Bruscelli LLC. The Steve Jones-bred has a summary of 6-3-4 from 21 appearances, has banked \$527,794, and returned \$11.70 to win as the 9-2 third choice. He was atop a \$49.20 exacta and a \$95.70 trifecta.

Two \$20,000 New York Excelsior Series races also took place, and they were won by:

- **DW's Cha-Ching** (by Devious Man and bred by Donald La Page, paid \$10.44 to win) in 1:57 for driver Matt Kakaley, trainer Travis Alexander and owner Stranger Stable;

With her best effort on display, **Odds On Monetary** (Huntsville—All On Top Hanover) notched her third straight victory by winning the \$121,800 New York Sires Stake for 3-year-old pacing fillies while handing the first loss of the year to the heavily favored Liberty Style at Batavia Downs on Wednesday (July 22), which was opening night of the summer/fall meet.

Liberty Style (Jason Bartlett) was first to the front while Odds On Monetary (Ridge Warren) also left, but had to navigate around the breaking Taladega Express (Leon Bailey) in the first turn. Eventually Liberty Style reached the quarter in :27.2 but as she was passing that station, Odds On Monetary was passing her, and crossed over to the pegs to take command in turn two. The race reached the half in :56.3 where the challenges would soon begin.

Surreal Spirit (Jeff Gregory) pulled first-over and made her way up to second in the breeze, just a length behind the leader. But that rush would stall in turn three, leaving Odds On Monetary and the pocket-stalking Liberty Style to battle from there on.

When Odds On Monetary turned for home, Liberty Style dipped into the passing lane and was under a drive. She made up over a length before the line, but came up a head shy of Odds On Monetary, who would not be denied and won in 1:54.2.

It was the third straight win for Odds On Monetary (\$19.68), who is owned by Odds On Racing and trained by Travis Alexander.

Odds On Monetary was bred by Crawford Farms.

There were also three \$20,000 Excelsior Series races on the card and all three were won by horses piloted by Bartlett.

The first was won by **Bueckers** (American Ideal—Finnish Your Way - 1:55, \$2.94), who is owned by Bonnie Benson, Ethan Stafford and Andrew Stafford, who also trains the filly. Stephen Dey III bred the winner.

The second was won by **Grazia** (Huntsville—Ramalama - 1:53.4, \$2.10), who is owned by Vincent Ferriero, Jr., Pint Size Racing, Dominic Pavia, and Steven Held, trained by Joe Pavia, Jr. and bred by Whiskeyontherocks Racing.

And the third was won by **Carry Back** (Huntsville—Hard Eight - 1:54, \$2.10), who is owned by The Bay's Stable, Polger Stables, Fred Wallace, and Richard Jack and trained by Linda Toscano. The Bay's Stable, Polger Holdings, South Mountain Stables, and Mark Mullen bred Carry Back.

Bartlett added a fourth win in an overnight event with **Granny's Watching** (1:54.4, \$6.04) to register a natural grand slam in races 3 through 6.

R Ro fought gamely and wound up as the runner-up while Flying Copper (Yannick Gingras) finished third. With the earnings from the Tuesday score, Sharp Seven moves to just shy of the half-million-dollar mark in career bankroll in just 18 lifetime starts.

The \$84,000 division of the NY Sire Stakes went the way of Who Dares Wins. Ake Svanstedt trains the 3-year-old filly who scored her second consecutive win in New York Sire Stakes competition when she went coast-to-coast with Gingras in the bike.

The sophomore filly was a winner by a length-and-a-quarter in 1:56.4 as she made good at odds of 3-5 besting longshot Chant (Jason Bartlett) who came up second-best while Julia Hot To Chill (Matt Kakaley) earned the show spot. Who Dares Wins is owned by Order By Stable Ab.

Fresh off winning seven Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) events on Sunday (July 19), Jody Jamieson piloted both victors in the \$100,000 OSS Gold leg 2 divisions for 2-year-old trotting fillies on Thursday (July 23) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Jamieson also shares ownership of both Gold winners – **Treasure King** and **Major Contender** – with his father, Hall of Famer Carl Jamieson, who also trains both King Of The North fillies.

In the first division (race 3), Treasure King posted a 30-1 upset, defeating leg 1 Gold winner Queen Of Bs (James MacDonald) by a neck in a career best 1:55.2.

The longest shot in the field of eight, Treasure King (out of Vanity Treasure) sat patiently near the back of the pack as Stormont Magenta (Mark MacDonald) led the group through fractions of :27.4, :57.2, and 1:26.2 with Queen Of Bs on her back. In

the stretch, Jody had Treasure King on the move, passing three horses and coming home in :28 to break her maiden in just her third lifetime start.

On July 5, **in her first Gold test of the year**, Treasure King was fifth in the division won by Verily.

“She wasn’t quite as good her first start,” Jody told Woodbine broadcaster John Rallis. “She was off her feed that week, but had no temperature, so we were able to race her. She was fifth in that first Gold, and I knew she had more to offer. I knew that if I got a trip like this, and she came off a helmet, she always tries hard. She never really has been tired in a race.”

Northern Song (Bob McClure) was third, followed by R Rosie (Doug McNair), and Rebel Moon (Trevor Henry).

Treasure King was purchased by the Jamiesons for \$42,000 U.S. at the 2025 Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling sale in Harrisburg, PA.

“Dad and I are our only partners on her,” Jody said. “We couldn’t find a partner for her all winter, but here we are in the winner’s circle for a Gold. So, we’re pretty happy.”

The trotter is now 1-1-0 in three starts and has earnings of \$58,134.

Treasure King paid \$62.50 to win.

In the second division (race 9), 8-5 favorite Major Contender sat near the back through the early going, crept up to third by the head of the lane and swept past Cold Breeze (MacDonald) and Twin B Kingsley (Henry) in the stretch to win by three lengths over another closer, Song From Heaven (Tyler Borth), in 1:54.4.

Twin B Kingsley led the field of eight through fractions of :27.3, :57.1, and 1:26, with Jody remaining patient with Major Contender.

Simea (McClure), who was in the hunt most of the mile, was third, followed, in order, by Northernlights Glo (Mark MacDonald), and Cold Breeze.

Major Contender paid \$5.20.

“[Major Contender] has been a perfect filly from the day she came home,” Jody said. “The people that sold her to us, I called them and asked them if she was maybe broke before they put her through the sale because she was so smart and she’s been so smart and I think that’s a trait with really good horses is that they’re really smart. I’m really hoping that she’s a really good horse.”

Major Contender broke her maiden in her second career start. She now sports earnings of \$66,008 and a record of 1-1-0 for her trainer and driver, plus Dave Lemon of London, ON and George Harrison of England.

Out of Major Muscle, Major Contender was bred by Princeton Farms Inc of Princeton, ON, Mark Etsell of Rockwood, ON, Robert

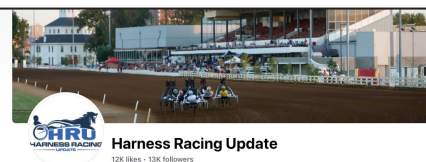

Sweet Valorie scores second seasonal BSS win to highlight second leg at Bucyrus

Sweet Valorie scored her second Buckeye Stallion Series win of the season on Wednesday (July 22) as the Crawford County Fair in Bucyrus, OH, hosted seven \$20,000 divisions of the second leg for freshman filly trotters.

Through two legs, Sweet Valorie is the lone freshman filly trotter with multiple BSS victories. She won Wednesday's fifth division by $3\frac{1}{4}$ lengths in 2:04.1 with Chris Lems driving for trainer Karen Fread, who co-owns with Jan Fread. The Volstead filly led gate-to-wire, posting fractions of :31.3, 1:02.4, and 1:34, and has now hit the board in all three seasonal starts with two wins and one second and earnings of \$23,000. Her lifetime mark of 1:58.1 came in the first leg of the BSS on July 14 at Eldorado Scioto Downs. Aunt Jessie (Leroy Eicher) and Range Queen (Bryce Brocklehurst) rounded out the top three in the fifth division.

Guardian Queen (Emanuel Miller) recorded the fastest mile of Wednesday's BSS races, winning the first division in gate-to-wire fashion in 2:00.2. The Guardian Angel As filly posted fractions of :30, :59.4, and 1:29.3 en route to winning by $5\frac{3}{4}$ lengths with Dd Silver Dollar (Sam Widger) and Angel L (Hank LeVan) rounding out the top three. Guardian Queen is trained by Herman Hagerman for owner Hagerman Racing. She has two wins and one third along with \$14,230 in earnings in four seasonal starts.

Indigo Times scored her first career victory, winning the second division in 2:01 with trainer Kayne Kauffman in the sulky. The In Range filly is owned by Parkview Stables, Redracer, Redline Racing Stables, and David Van Dusen. Shinie T (Chris Beaver) led the field past the first three calls in :30.4, :59.4, and 1:30. Indigo Times was in third place and trailed the leader by more than five lengths at the halfway mark before rallying to win by a half-length. Shinie T was second followed by Lindy's Moni (Russell Swartz) in third.

Lady Martinique (Kauffman) took the third division by three-quarters-of-a-length in 2:03 for trainer Peter Foley and owner Lynne Foley. The Marseille filly led gate-to-wire with fractions of :30, 1:01.2, and 1:32.2 en route to her first career victory. Center Field Lady (Ronnie Gillespie) and Just Gee (Clifton Bell)

rounded out the top three. Lady Martinique has hit the board in three of five seasonal starts, banking \$13,285.

Dublins Tessa (Bell) won the fourth division in gate-to-wire fashion in 2:04.3. The Volstead filly recorded fractions of :32.1, 1:03, and 1:34 in what was her first career win. Lavish Reign (Brocklehurst) was second followed by Alleluia (Gillespie) in third. Dublins Tessa led by seven lengths at the three-quarter pole before Lavish Reign closed the gap to $2\frac{1}{2}$ lengths at the finish. Dublins Tessa is trained by Beaver, who co-owns the filly with Joe Sbrocco, Bill Manes, and Leo Fleming. She has \$12,191 in seasonal earnings.

Wishinghallofchina (Widger) led gate-to-wire with fractions of :30.1, :59.1, and 1:30.4 en route to winning the sixth division by $3\frac{1}{2}$ lengths in a lifetime-best 2:01.2. The Enterprise filly is trained by Randy Rank, who co-owns with Roger Huard. She has now hit the board in all five seasonal starts with two wins, two seconds, and one third to go with \$18,148 in earnings. Shes In My Range (Gillespie) was second followed by Betterbehoppin (Miller) in third.

The seventh division went to **Rollin Range** (Gillespie) in 2:04.1. It was the first career win for the In Range filly, increasing her earnings to \$12,651. She is trained by Deborah Swartz for owners Matt Rowe, Adam Friedland, Brian Carsey, and Thomas Adams. Rollin Range was in fourth place and trailed leader Dun Cashed It (Pierce Henry) by two lengths at the three-quarter pole before winning by three-quarters-of-a-length over Queen Mira (Lavern Hostetler). Hills Of Glory (Miller) finished third.

Alongside his wife, Debbie, and their children, Brandy and Jody, Carl built more than a successful operation – he established a family legacy that has become synonymous with excellence in Canadian harness racing.

This weekend, Carl returns to the sulky to compete in the \$15,000 Legends Day Invitational Trot, joining fellow Hall of Fame and legendary drivers who helped shape the sport as part of Clinton Raceway's biennial event.

Carl's son, Jody, has carried that legacy forward, becoming one of Canada's most accomplished drivers. On Sunday (July 26), he'll compete for the National Driving Championship title and the opportunity to represent Canada at the 2027 World Driving Championship.

Adding another chapter to the family's remarkable story is Jody's daughter, Siara Jamieson, who will compete in the Junior National Driving Championship with her miniature pony, Looney Tunes on Saturday, as part of the weekend festivities.

Seeing three generations of the same family compete on the same weekend is a rare and special moment.

"This weekend is pretty special for our family" Jody said. "It's really a full-circle moment. It all started with my dad, and now to have him driving in the Legends Day Invitational Trot, while I'm competing for a chance to represent Canada at the World Driving Championship, and then seeing Siara taking part in the Junior National Driving Championship – it's something we never could have imagined. To have three generations of our family all participating in one weekend at the same racetrack is incredibly meaningful."

When asked who gives the best advice and who listens the best, Jody doesn't hesitate.

"I'd like to think I give the best advice," Jody said with a laugh. "Whether dad or Siara actually listen is another story."

Siara added, "I agree with dad, Because he's one of the best drivers, he gives both good advice and listens too."

For Carl, it's another chance to experience the thrill of race day while sharing the track with fellow legends. For Jody, it's an opportunity to chase another career milestone. And for Siara, it's the beginning of what everyone hopes will be a lifetime of cherished memories in the sport that has shaped her family for generations.

"I'm incredibly proud that we have three generations of our family racing at Clinton Raceway this weekend," Carl said. "I learned from my parents, then Jody learned from me, and now it's rewarding to watch both Jett and Siara learning from the



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two of us. That's what makes this sport so special — it's a tradition that's passed from one generation to the next."

With a smile, Carl didn't hesitate when asked who gives the best advice in the family.

"That would be me, of course," he said with a laugh. "And they always listen... at least I'd like to think they do."

Carl says one lesson has guided him throughout his career in harness racing.

"Always be willing to listen to new ideas," he said. "Don't knock it until you try it. That's something I've always believed, and it's served me well over the years."

The Jamieson story is about more than championships, accolades, and who gives the best advice. It's about taking a chance on a dream, building a life around horses, and passing that passion from one generation to the next.

This weekend at Clinton Raceway, fans won't just witness great racing — they'll witness a family's legacy coming full circle.

Three generations. Three competitors. One unforgettable weekend that perfectly captures what harness racing is all about.

There are some exceptions to those rules.

The 101st edition of the \$1-million Hambletonian is on Saturday (Aug. 8), and that card begins at noon.

On Saturday (Aug. 15), racing will begin at 7 p.m.

In addition, there is a Thursday program scheduled. It will take place on Aug. 6.

Finally, there will be no live racing at The Meadowlands on Friday (Aug. 14), and Friday (Aug. 28), due to preseason football at MetLife Stadium.

A CLOSE RACE: With just seven race cards remaining in the Winter-Spring-Championship Meet, the battle for who will walk away with the title as top driver is still very much up for grabs.

It's a two-way scrum, as Brett Beckwith, whose 146 wins led The Big M in 2025, currently has 92 victories. Joe Bongiorno is in hot pursuit with 87. Both drivers won four races over the course of last weekend (July 17-18).

The duo is incredibly close when it comes to how effective they have been for their backers. Beckwith wins at a rate of 22 per cent, while Bongiorno scores at a 21.2 per cent clip.

WHO'S ON THE SHOW? This weekend, Cheyenne Christman will be back on the Sam McKee Memorial Set sharing her insights and selections alongside Big M simulcast show host Dave Little.

Christman is a multimedia content specialist with the United States Trotting Association, where she directs HarnessRacing.com preview shows, designs graphics, manages social media content, and occasionally conducts on-air interviews. She has recently expanded her role to include serving as the USTA's strategic wagers analyst.

A third-generation horsewoman on both sides of her family, she has been around horses since the age of 3 and has worked with numerous trainers at The Meadows. In addition to her work with the USTA, she is also a freelance social media content creator and manager for various harness racing entities.

Ken Warkentin will be in his place at the top of the grandstand calling the action for both programs, while Gary DiLeo will handle interviews from the paddock with winning connections.
