# Cokstile upsets in third B-race in Paris

The \$135,000 Prix de Bourgogne over 1.3 miles was held at Vincennes racetrack on Sunday (Jan. 2) afternoon and as in all B-races, three spots in the Prix d'Amérique were at stake.

The bettors put their trust in two horses when the field of 18 trotters gathered behind the car at Vincennes. Elitloppet winner and runner up, Don Fanucci Zet and Vivid Wise As, respectively, were first and second choice and both horses opened well behind the gate. Vivid Wise As came to the lead for driver Eric Raffin since early leader Cokstile (Quite Easy), paired with Gabriele Gelormoni, opted the pocket position behind Alessandro Gocciadoro's Vivid Wise As.

Don Fanucci Zet tried three wide in the last turn as he left position in second over, but the Swedish 5-year-old couldn't fight for a top placing in his first attempt in Paris. Instead it was the three horses trotting in front on the inside that secured their Prix d'Amérique-spots, respectively.

Cokstile (Gabriele Gelormini) won the \$135,000 Prix de Bourgogne on Sunday (Jan. 2) at Vincennes to qualify for the Prix d'Amerique final. Cokstile left his position behind Vivid Wise As when the field reached the home stretch and pretty easily, the leader was disarmed by the top Norwegian-bred trotter.

Cokstile, now trained by Erik Bondo in Italy, sprinted to a safe win in a mile rate of 1:54 while runner up Vivid Wise As came home in 1:54.2. (**Replay here**)

Eleven-year-old Billie de Montfort continues to surprise in big races and Sébastien Guarato's mare claimed the bronze medal after a third inside trip.

One B-race remains. On Jan. 16, the \$135,000 Prix de Belgique is scheduled at Vincennes and that will be the last chance for horses to qualify for Prix d'Amérique.



# Ladies In Red wins Vicbred final to cap remarkable first two years

On a night of stars and remarkable performances, it was fitting champion filly Ladies In Red again stole the show.

On the last night of 2021, **Ladies In Red** iced the most remarkable first two years of racing and stirred the debate as to whether she's as good a 3-year-old filly as we've ever seen Down Under.

I'll leave that debate to others, but she certainly ticks every box you need to be a champion... and more.

Just as she's done in all the big ones this season, Ladies In Red overcame a bad draw and tough run to win her Vicbred final on Friday (Dec. 31) Tabcorp Park, while also smashing the clock.

This time she made an early move from a back row draw to sit parked and driver David Moran crushed the leader, stablemate and main danger Joanna with a :56.2 split from the 1200-400m. She then held-off another star stablemate, Rogue Wave, to win by 1.5m with a 26.8sec closing split and 1:54.8 mile rate for 2,240m.

Ladies In Red has that strong U.S. connection being by Mach Three out of former U.S. race mare Kabbalah Karen B.

Owner/breeders Bill and Anne Anderson, along with trainers Emma Stewart and Clayton Tonkin, gave her a long spell and sacrificed the first half of this season with a view to dominating the back half.

That she did, winning the big three: Victoria Oaks, Breeders Crown and Vicbred finals. She's won 17 of her 20 starts.

Her driver, David Moran, captured the moment (and season) superbly. "It's a privilege to drive her. I don't think you quite understand it or respect it enough early in horses' careers. It's when they start to get on and do more and more amazing things you realise you've been a part of a very special time in a very special horse's career," he told TrotsVision on the night.

"She never seems to disappoint in the finals. She's just an amazing horse, the things she does and how she does it. She's one of a kind, that's for sure."

Bill Anderson added a lovely insight into how popular the filly is.

"People ask us all the time, can I have a photo taken with her – people really want to be included. We need a profile horse in this industry and I think, hopefully, she's the one to do it," he said. "When you breed them, and she was around the farm for probably 13 or 14 months – personality plus – it's a great reward."

We won't have to wait long to see if Ladies In Red's juvenile dominance can translate into open-class success.

"We're freshening her up now to have a go at either the Ladyship Mile or Chariots Of Fire in Sydney next month," Bill Anderson said.

Success in either race would get her a ticket into the big dance, Australia's premier speed test, the \$A1 million Miracle Mile at Menangle on March 5.

The Andersons may have two Miracle Mile runners with their lightly raced but electrifyingly brilliant 4-year-old Honolua Bay also aiming for the sprint.

The son of Somebeachsomewhere made it five wins from as many starts back from a breathing operation (and 14 from 21 lifetime) when he didn't plenty of work and kept finding to win his Vicbred final by 2.5m in a 1:53.7 mile rate for 2,240m.

"We've had the Miracle Mile in mind for a while if he kept stepping-up," Bill Anderson said. "He'll have a freshen-up now and we'll head in that direction." Somebeachsomewhere also sired another of the star performers of the night in blossoming colt Bondi Lockdown, who overcame early trouble to sit parked and crush his rivals in a blistering 1:53.4 mile rate for 2,240m.

He's trained and driven by Aaron Dunn, who only has 10 in work and qualified five of them for Vicbred finals.

"I've got some nice horses and had a really good one in Dee Dees Dream in the past. He won my first Group 1, but I've thought from day one this guy could be better... and he is," Dunn said.

"He's got his quirks and he's taken some time to work through them. They'll always be there, but he copes better with them now. I thought he'd gone to a new level going into the final and that's how he raced."

Bondi Lockdown is yet another Vicbred star being set for a New South Wales (NSW) raid. His target being next month's Group 1 Chariots Of Fire, Australasia's premiers 4YO feature.

You can also add Vicbred 2YO Fillies' winner Amore Vita, a daughter of Art Major, to the team of NSW raiders.

She's trained by Nathan Purdon, son of New Zealand Hall of Famer Mark Purdon, and he's got his sights set on the NSW Oaks.

It capped a mighty first 12 months for Purdon since he shocked many by leaving NZ to make Victoria (Australia) home.

"It's certainly exceeded expectations, but I did set the bar high. When you leave friends and family and go to another country, you need to be really successful to make it worthwhile," he said.

Purdon's headline act, champion mare Amazing Dream, could also be part of the NSW carnival next month, despite her U.S. owners longing for her to head to North America to continue her racing career.

"She'll race next in the Ballarat Cup (Jan. 22) and then Hunter Cup (Feb. 5). The Ladyship and Miracle Mile are getting closer and she's not locked into a flight (to the U.S.) yet, so I'm keeping everything crossed she stays. She'd be so well suited up there," Purdon said.

Some of the other highlights of Vicbred finals night included:

Champion driver Kerryn Manning snaring two finals on 2YO



Born in New Jersey, Roman did not come from a horsey family, but that didn't cease the desire to be around and work with horses.

"I have loved horses from birth. I'm not sure exactly where that came from, but as a baby my parents could never tell if I was crying or neighing.

"After years begging my parents, I started taking riding lessons with my sisters at a backyard stable. Although my siblings lost interest fairly quickly, I persevered.

"I worked at a young age for the opportunity to ride and learn whatever I could, as my parents' support was minimal.

"I grew up riding hunters/jumpers and many off track thoroughbreds.

"I always had a love for horse racing and sometimes I would go to Freehold Raceway, which wasn't far from my home. But other than that, I had zero experience with standardbred horses.

"That was, until 2016 when I acquired a standardbred foal to keep her from going to the auction. I named her Witch Hazel (Hazel) and she turned into an amazing show horse and partner.

"This would be the start of my love for standardbreds and helping to save as many as I could.

"Initially, I was skeptical, for I was told standardbreds were 'no good jug heads' that could not canter, but Hazel sure proved them all wrong.

"Her incredible intelligence, sturdiness, and attitude, won me over and I became very interested in this 'underdog' breed that many people had talked down on.

"I've always loved the underdogs, so this led me to work at a standardbred rescue where I saddle broke and adopted out hundreds of standardbreds.

"I continued to be amazed at the horse's willingness to learn and please, and amazingly enough to forgive.

"To better understand how to properly retrain these horses I needed to learn more about the breed, so I took a job as a groom and discovered a never-ending love for harness racing as well.

"I worked for trainer Gary Candell at the Takter farm where I groomed horses such as SUNFIRE BLUE CHIP and GREAT VINTAGE. One of the horses I cared for was a trotter named STORMING MIST, who I later tracked down and bought back from the Amish. Today, STORMING MIST is a very successful show horse.

"I also worked for Chris Ryder.

"After working at the track I connected to a lot of people involved with racing and began getting flooded with requests to take horses off the track and adopt them out.

"Initially, I was apprehensive to make the leap taking horses in full time (for financial reasons), but my love and desire to help the horses overcame my fear. "The word got out and it's been a steady stream ever since. I spent so much time promoting the horses to a second career and keep them from ending up in a kill pen, I figured it was time to step up to the plate and devote every minute to it.

"Some of the horses I have placed are ROCKIN ROCKO, PITTSTOP KIP, COLD CERTIFIED, TAYLORLANE CRUISER, POP ART K, KATHY'S CHAMP, MUSCLES OVER HALL and SCOOTER SHOP."

Roman explained the process in training an ex-racehorse for a second career and how these lucky equines come to her.

"Usually I'm contacted by a trainer or owner asking if I can take on the horse and find it a good home, and rehab if needed. Occasionally, I do get some from the kill pen, like POP ART K who I rescued, for he was LUCKY's brother.

"When I get a horse I first gather as much information on them as I can — especially about prior injuries as these can limit what a horse can safely do.

"I evaluate the horse as far as his temperament and movement (if they are smooth or bouncy). I develop him into a career he enjoys and can succeed at, making him an enjoyable, safe, well-rounded horse until the right situation comes up for him.

"Once the new owner is approved, I schedule a visit for them to come visit and see if the two connect.

"I'm all about educating, promoting and retraining of the standardbred horse and the proper use in a second career.

"I have a Facebook group that has now reached 12,000 members where we share tips and tricks on retraining. We have found tons of horses new homes, helped track down someone's ex-horse and have connected people to their horse in question's conditions ---besides making hundreds of new friends with horse lovers.

"Currently I'm enhancing my veterinary knowledge, working as a vet tech at Colts Neck Equine. I'm also working on getting my trainer's license — all I have left is to finish the testing process. I'm super excited about this.

"Presently, I own three horses; my two show horses, Hazel and Stormy, and Lucky (Luck N Roll K) who currently races and helps support the adoptable horses."

Roman is never too busy to help these horses. In fact, she was the one that contacted the USTA and drafted the initial proposal for the new Standardbred Incentive Program (SIP).

"We all need to work together for the benefit of the common denominator and give back to the wonderful standardbred horse who gives so much to us!"

"Is that good or bad? Should we kill the machines before they kill us?"


He picked at the label on his beer bottle and spoke slowly, "I'm not sure, but keep your hammer handy."

# Township votes to allow Gaitway Farm to be redeveloped

Steve Strunsky of NJ Advance Media reported on Dec. 30 for www. NJ.com (full story here) that the Manalapan Township Committee in New Jersey voted 4-0 on Dec. 29 to "allow warehouses and sports complexes on a 225-acre swath along Route 33 occupied mainly by the pastures, pens, stables and practice tracks at Gaitway Farm, New Jersey's main training facility for the standardbred horses."

Gaitway, which is home to 550 horses, is owned by brothers Kenneth Jr., Gary and Jeffrey Fischer.

Jennifer Beahm, the township's planning consultant, told Strunsky that the plan does not give Manalapan authorization to condemn the property and turn it over to a developer.

"If the owner of Gaitway Farm does not want to sell, they do not have to do so," Beahm said.

It is unclear what the farm owners want to do with the property, though it has been suggested the brothers are interested in putting warehouses on the site.

Wednesday's meeting was attended by more than 30 people, "virtually all of them were opposed to the redevelopment plan," Strunsky wrote. Most in attendance were from the standardbred industry.

# Tim Tetrick wins 10, tying Philly record on closing day

Tim Tetrick provided the fireworks on the final card of the 2021 racing season at Harrah's Philadelphia, as he guided home 10 winners on the 15-race Dec. 31 program to equal the all-time record at the riverside oval first set by George Napolitano Jr. on November 11, 2009. Tetrick, who drove in 14 races, was victorious in races one, two, three, six, nine, 10, 12, 13, 14 and the climatic 15th.

The last race matched up Tetrick driving 11-1 outsider Searching For You, a frequent winner in Iowa but far back upon coming to this class, and 1-5 favorite Vendor Bill, who had a first and two seconds in his last three starts at this level and was driven by – George Napolitano Jr.

Vendor Bill went first-over, with Searching For You in Tetrick-typical second-over position; when the chalk cleared into the final turn, Searching For You went right up to him, and from midstretch it was certain that Tetrick was going to write yet another line in local record books that have his name all over them.

He wound up the meet with 269 victories, his seventh dash driving championship at Harrah's Philadelphia; early in the day he had been presented with a congratulatory sign in the winner's circle. He is solidly second behind ironman Aaron Merriman in the 2021 North American standings.

The 2019 Little Brown Jug winner Southwind Ozzi became the sport's newest millionaire with a powerful 1:50 victory in an \$11,200 pace. Laying off a contested :26.3 quarter, the son of Somebeachsomewhere rushed to command before a :54.4 half, held sway to the 1:22.3 three-quarters, then just ran away from his field to boost his earnings to \$1,000,649 for trainer Bill Mac Kenzie and owners Vincent Ali Jr. and Alma Lafelice. He was one of Timmy T's Ten on the card.

Ron Burke had four winners over the last two cards to bring his yearly local total to 78, enabling him to defend his title as



winningest trainer and taking his ninth such championship at the Philadelphia oval.

Siblings Jennifer and Joe Bongiorno won the percentage titles for trainers and drivers, respectively. Jennifer won her second local UTR crown in the most dramatic manner possible: trailing Tony Alagna .466 to .464, Jenn needed her last starter of the meet, Tuesday Morning, to win, second place wouldn't do. And win the trotter did, giving Jenn a final margin of .467 to .466!

Joe, who drove Tuesday Morning, beat out the all-star driving colony with a .421 UDR, and in doing so became only the fifth driver in the 16-year history at Harrah's to win a driving title, joining Cat Manzi, Tim Tetrick, George Napolitano Jr., and Yannick Gingras.

Racing will resume at Harrah's Philadelphia on April 4, 2022.

# \$27K Pick-5 payout highlights Big M 2021 finale

The final night of racing in 2021 at The Meadowlands featured a big 20-cent Pick-5 carryover – and payout – as well as a big night for driver Scott Zeron, who scored four times on the 14-race Friday night (Dec. 31) program.

The action in the Pick-5 was fast and furious as a \$38,923.56 carryover led to \$231,849.96 in "new money" being poured into the pot for a total pool of \$270,773. The excitement gained big-time momentum after driver Johnathan Ahle guided 57-1 shot Galactic Galleon N to victory lane in the second race GSY Final, and when the will pays were posted before the start of the fifth race, there were three possibilities of single-ticket winners walking away with better than \$230,000.

The big payoff wasn't to be, but those who cashed did not complain.

Perfectboy Hanover and Zeron took the fifth race at odds of 4-1 to complete the Pick-5, which returned \$27,565.46. Other than the 50-1 shot, the odds of the other four winners were 5-1,5-1, 5-1 and 4-1. There were no winning favorites.

The 20-cent Pick-6 saw a modest \$6,131 carryover grow to a total pool of over \$39,000, and one shrewd player had the only winning ticket that returned \$34,157. The sequence saw a 50-1 bomb joined by horses who were sent off at 2-1, 1-2, 3-2, 7-2 and 5-1.

With the top six drivers at the Fall Meeting taking the night off, Zeron – currently No. 7 – had his way, as in addition to his win in the fifth race, he was on target with 8-1 chance Monty Mono in the sixth race; 2-1 shot Opus Blue Chip in the seventh; and Skyway Kon Man, who went off at 3-2 in the 11th.

\$3 MILLION PER: The Meadowlands had a remarkable 2021 from a handle perspective, finishing the 92 race cards with an average wager per card of just over \$3 million.

Wagering on the Dec. 31 card totaled \$2,973,353, bringing total betting for the calendar year to \$276,031,079, good for an average of \$3,000,337 per card.

GETTING IT DUNN: After being the leading driver at both the Winter-Spring-Championship and Fall Meetings, Dexter Dunn finished the year atop the Big M standings with 166 victories. Yannick Gingras was second with 116.

Ron Burke finished second to Jeff Cullipher in the W-S-C Meeting but won 30 times in the Fall to pass Cullipher for the year 78 wins to 71.

A LITTLE MORE: The Pick-5 and Pick-6 weren't the only big payouts on the card, as the 20-cent Survivor Pick-7 returned \$7,015, despite it taking only five correct selections to do it... 20-year-old Trae Porter recorded his first-ever Big M win when he scored with 7-2 chance Doctor Butch from just off the pace in race 12... The Meadowlands has no live racing on Saturday, Jan. 1 and will return with live action on Friday, Jan. 7 at 6:20 p.m.

# Bourbans Best sings a winning swan song at MGM Northfield Park

Fourteen-year-old Bourbans Best scored in his final race Thursday (Dec. 30) at MGM Northfield Park. As the calendar will be turning to 2022 Bourbans Best will be forced into retirement per the rules of the United States Trotting Association because every race horse turns a year older each Jan. 1.

Bourbans Best (Pro Bono Best–Mattachevitz) from post two (after a scratch to his inside) in the evening's \$6,000 claiming event. He led his competition at every call through fractions of :27.4, :57.2, 1:26.2 and 1:55.4, beating his competition by 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ -lengths. He was heavily favored in the race and paid \$2.20 to win.

The classy veteran leaves racing with 472 career starts resulting in 58 wins, 62 seconds and 62 third-place finishes. Bourbans Best has career earnings of \$337,864 with a lifetime mark of 1:52, taken at Northfield at age 12.

The gelding's richest win was for a purse of \$14,000 in a Late Closing Series final at Northfield in 2019. Bourbans Best is a well-traveled campaigner as his 472 starts have been spread across 12 different racing surfaces.

Ashley Burke of Mount Vernon, OH owns and trains Bourbans Best. Chris Lems drove the racing stalwart in his career finale.

# Meadowlands sets 2022 dates, racing to start Jan. 7

Live harness racing at The Meadowlands for 2022 kicks off on Friday night, Jan. 7, with the first of 90 programs on the calendar.

The mile oval will race for 31 consecutive weeks on a Friday-Saturday basis until Hambletonian Day, Saturday, Aug. 6. Post time for every race card is 6:20 p.m. with the exception of the Hambletonian program, when the first race will head to the gate at noon.

There will also be three Thursday evening cards sprinkled in during the Winter-Spring-Championship Meeting with racing on June 30, July 7 and Aug. 4.

After a three-week hiatus, racing will then return for eight nights in September, with live action on the 2nd, 3rd, 9th, 10th, 16th and 17th. There will also be two Thursday night cards, on the 1st and 8th.

The track will then go dark for six weeks before returning in November, when all four weekends will have live racing.

The final nine days of racing are slated to take place during December, with live action every Friday and Saturday (except for the 23rd and 24th) plus one Thursday program, on the 1st.

In total, there are 42 weeks of racing, 36 of which will have two programs, and six that will have three.

MAKE SURE YOU ARE THERE: The Meadowlands always has three dates worth circling on its calendar, and during 2022, those dates are July 16 (Meadowlands Pace), Aug. 6 (Hambletonian) and Nov. 26 (Fall Final Four/TVG Finals Night).


# Miami Valley kicks off its ninth season today

Miami Valley Raceway is set to kick off its ninth season of live racing today (Jan. 3), with a new weekly schedule and a new 4:05 matinee post time each day. Programs will be presented five consecutive days each week from Sunday through Thursday, with no racing on Fridays (other than qualifiers) or Saturdays. Only exceptions will be dark days on Super Bowl Sunday and Easter Sunday, as well as an earlier post time on closing day, Saturday, May 7 (Kentucky Derby Day).

The Monday lid-lifter features a \$30,000 open trot in the 11th of 14 races. Purses for the day are \$176,000, just a hair below the average daily purse disbursement target for the meet. Day Two on Tuesday (Jan. 4) will feature another 14-race card with total purses of \$171,500.

All 10 of the top drivers on the southern Ohio harness racing circuit (Miami Valley, Scioto Downs and Dayton Raceway) have relocated their tack for the coming meet, in addition to four of nearby Hoosier Park's top reinsmen. The driving colony at Miami Valley is one of the strongest and most competitive in the country.
