Doping trial stories dominate HRU's most read stories

You'll notice a definite theme in our most read stories of 2022.

Before we get to our most read stories of 2022: Happy New Year! All of us at Harness Racing Update (HRU) send our deepest gratitude to our advertisers, readers, and contributors for the support in 2022.

This week marks seven years since the new management took over HRU in January of 2016. Since that time, we have gained a little over 2,700 HRU subscribers, an increase of 46 per cent.

In 2022, specifically, we increased our number of subscribers by 2.5 per cent in a year.

We are extremely proud and thankful to continue to show year-over-year growth.

Even more important, HRU's average click and open rates continue to greatly exceed industry standards.

In 2022, our average open rate improved over 2021, exceeding 51 per cent, which is 23 per cent higher than the industry average. our click-to-open rate of 33 per cent is 14 per cent higher than the industry average.

HRU continued to post steady growth in other areas, as well. In 2018, we launched our popular **broadcast division** with 2-year-olds in Training and sales coverage. In 2022, our YouTube subscribers nearly reached 2,000, up some 400 subscribers from the end of 2021.

Also, the number of people that like our Facebook page ([harnessracingupdate.com/facebook](https://www.facebook.com/harnessracingupdate)) has organically grown (not paid) by over 500 (up almost 5 per cent) just in 2022.

Finally, our number of Twitter followers increased by 361 followers in 2022.

All that means HRU is showing growth in virtually every category.

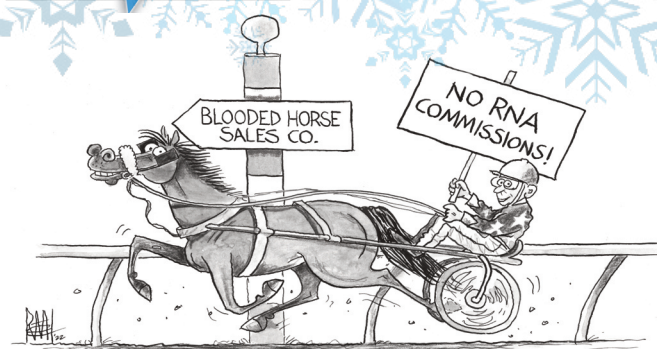

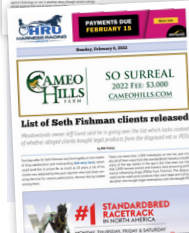

EUROPEAN REPORT

Female dominance on the Prix d'Amérique path

The third B-race, the \$125,000 Prix de Bourgogne over 2,100 meters, was held at Vincennes in Paris on Sunday (Jan. 1) afternoon and the female trotters dominated the race.

Five mares entered the 1.3 miles long race and four finished 1-4, as the grand old lady **Delia du Pommereux** (Niky), paired with Pierre Yves Verva, claimed an upset win in a 1:52 track record.

The race's favorite, Jean-Michel Bazire-trained Heraut d'Armes, was pushed to the lead with 550 meters to go as leader Etonnant (who made a short break in the start) ran out of power in the last turn. And it looked pretty safe for Bazire's horse in the lead as

the field turned for home, but just as the stretch began, Heraut d'Armes went off stride and Delia du Pommereux, who did the heavy job as first over most of the race, got the advantage and held on to the win.

Sylvain Roger's 10-year-old trotter will face her fifth start in Prix d'Amérique (finished 4th in 2021) and along with her, Thierry Duvaldestin-trained Flamme du Goutier, who was third in Prix d'Amérique 2022, will follow.

Already qualified Ampia Mede Sm was third and Decoloration was fourth and she will get a new chance to qualify in Prix de Belgique on Jan. 15.

Thierry Duvaldestin's Idao de Tillard, who won the \$210,000 Criterium Continental at Vincennes on Dec. 24, will enter the Prix d'Amérique on Jan. 29. The 5-year-old trotter is in such a good shape that the trainer has decided to try the big race already this year.

RAITALA OVER 400 WINS

Finnish driver Santtu Raitala had a great 2022 and was superior to his fellow drivers in Finland during 2022. Raitala entered the winner's circle on 402 occasions and dominated the sport big time in his home country.

Raitala was born in 1991. Nine years younger is Sweden's best driver in 2022. Magnus A Djuse's career has been nothing but successful and superlatives hardly describe the young man's abilities on the track. For the first time, Djuse collected the prestigious driver's championship in Sweden.

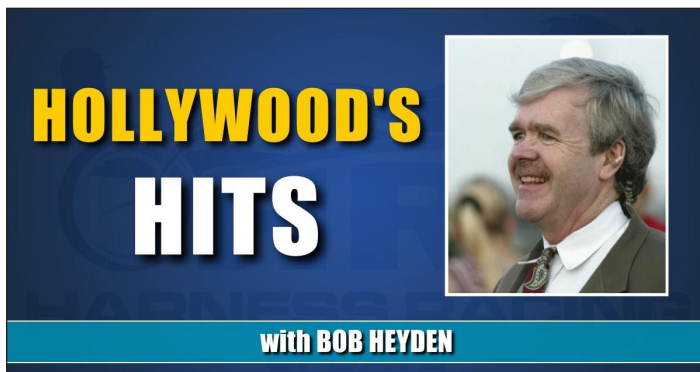

Celebrating important anniversaries in harness racing history

Now that it's 2023, it's time to look through some notable standardbred history notes that fall on anniversary years:

170 years ago in 1853 Freehold Raceway opened.

130 years ago in 1893 the inaugural Kentucky Futurity was won by Oro Wilkes.

100 years ago in 1923 both Billy Haughton and Howard Beissinger were born.

90 years ago in 1933 Glen Garnsey was born on New Year's Day. Garnsey did something never seen before or since. He raced three \$100 million sires in a five-year span: Abercrombie (1978-79), Balanced Image (1981-82) and No Nukes (1982).

80 years ago in 1943 Adios turned 3 and Victory Song, the very first Horse of the Year winner was born. Also, Yonkers played host to the Hambletonian for the one and only time.

70 years ago in 1953 Helicopter won the 1953 Hambletonian, trainer Jack Darling was born and Scott Frost became the first yearling sold publicly to win a Triple Crown.

60 years ago in 1963 Bret Hanover topped the Harrisburg sale at \$50,000 and went on to a three-time HOY career. Also, Mohawk Raceway opened on April 28 and The Meadows opened on June 28, 1963.

50 years ago in 1973 John Campbell was 18 and is in his first full year as a driver. Plans to build a Meadowlands in East Rutherford were also finalized.

40 years ago in 1983 Ralph Hanover won the Triple Crown and the Meadowlands Pace (not done since). He also rewrote the record book for 3-year-old earnings at \$1,711,990. But Cam Fella was the HOY, again, and to this day no pacer has won it back to back since. The same year, the first million-dollar trot was held (the Hambletonian won by Duenna and Stanley Dancer). Also, simulcasting debuts mostly on a limited basis to and from Atlantic City Racecourse and the Meadowlands.

30 years ago in 1993 Presidential Ball had the biggest money season ever for a non-Horse of the Year: \$2,222,166. Also, both Moni Maker and Continental Victory were born.

20 years ago in 2003 the entire trajectory of Brian Sears' career changes on April 30, 2003 when he enters the driving room full time at the Meadowlands. No Pan Intended won the Breeders Crown and the Triple Crown – still unmatched. Eternal Camnation won her third Breeders Crown and would retire the following year as the richest pacing female ever (\$3.7 million). Stephane Bouchard led North America in wins (656) aided by 11 in a row on March 8.

10 years ago in 2013 Bee A Magician went unblemished (17-for-17) and set the all-time single-season money record (over \$1.5 million) in the Moni Maker set by Moni Maker en route to the Horse of the Year award.





Keeping the Dream alive

For the sixth consecutive year, The Meadowlands will host races paying tribute to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

According to Big M race secretary Scott Warren, the track plans to hold four races in honor of the civil rights pioneer.

"There will be a Martin Luther King Remembrance race on Friday [Jan. 13] and there'll be one on Saturday [Jan. 14]," said Warren. "If I end up with an odd number [more than 10 competitors], some of them may have to sit out since only five can compete when we have an MLK/pro race each night."

Driver Jim King Solomon is the driving force behind the competition and is so happy to see the top track in the sport

involved with this event, which, for the second straight year, is being sponsored by trainer Tony Alagna.

"I'm very proud of it, because we're doing it in memory of an icon, Dr. Martin Luther King," said Solomon. "I'm happy that The Meadowlands is hosting it, which I never thought would happen. But they came through. I also can't thank Tony Alagna enough for being our sponsor."

In 2022, for the first time since the MLK tribute races started at The Meadowlands in 2018, it grew from just one race featuring African-American drivers on one night, to a two-night event with a total of four races featuring two MLK Remembrance races and two unity races, which were labelled GSY/MLK Remembrance and Pro/MLK Remembrance.

Driver Devon Tharps, who won the 2021 MLK Remembrance race, told The Meadowlands' Jessica Otten in an interview last year

that he was pleased to have the MLK drivers compete against both the GSY and pro drivers.

"Martin Luther King didn't stand for just black people only," said Tharps, who went on to say he'd like to see the unity races renamed to better reflect Dr. King's dream.

After much consideration, The Meadowlands will embrace the 2023 MLK theme "Together We Can Be THE Dream" for the two races joining the MLK drivers and Meadowlands' regulars.

James Davis, Meadowlands' senior security manager, will be in the winner's circle making presentations to the MLK race winners who are expected to receive a commemorative race blanket.

With the event only a week away, Warren believes he may get some last-minute interest from drivers wishing to compete, but he hopes to have the competitors list finalized this weekend in advance of the draw on Tuesday, Jan. 11.

Previous competitors expected to return this year are Randy Crisler, Michael Cruse, Mark Sheridan, Newton (Yogi) Sheridan, Solomon and Eric Tharps, Jr.

New to the competition in 2023 are Jeremy Bobbitt, who made his first appearance at The Big M last year, DeShawn Minor, who last competed at The Meadowlands in 2014, and Jordan Ross, who is making his Big M debut.

"I don't know [Jordan] personally but I know he had a very successful meet out [at Hoosier Park]," said Warren. "And I know

a couple people out there, like Jay and Homer Hochstetler, spoke very highly of him. More than Homer did the Lew Williams comparison. The kid's very talented."

Ross, 25, grew up watching The Meadowlands and is excited for the opportunity to compete there.

"It would be a huge, huge experience because it's the main track you hear about," said Ross. "If somebody says harness racing, The Meadowlands is probably the top track they're talking about. Everybody says it's a beautiful place and I just want to see how the track is, because they say it's one of the best tracks ever."

Ross is coming off a career year with 1,084 starts and 153 wins, while hitting the board an impressive 41 per cent of the time. During his career, he has – on occasion – competed against some of the top drivers in the sport.

"I've been out there with Dexter Dunn a couple of times," said Ross. "I've driven with Tim [Tetrack], Dave [Miller], Yannick [Gingras] and I think I drove with Mark MacDonald for the first time in 2022. I'm kind of used to being in the mix with them."

Through Solomon's hard work and the kind cooperation of Alagna, Warren and everyone at The Meadowlands, they are indeed honoring the memory of a great man because together they can be the dream.

Ohio-based caretaker Steve Gibson feels lucky to work with horses

Steve Gibson's current clientele includes a "Queen" and a "Princess," which is only fitting considering the racing royalty he's worked with over the years.

The 2-year-old trotting fillies, Little Bit of Fran, and Check Worthy, have yet to race, but the pair is already receiving gold-standard care from their doting groom.

"I'm really excited about these two babies," said Gibson, who calls Mechanicsburg, OH, home. "I call Little Bit of Fran 'Queen' and Check Worthy is 'Princess.' They are two of my favorite ones. I work with them and get them ready every day. One girl who cleans stalls, she always gets on me for spoiling them. I go in and clean 'Frannie's' stall and do whatever, but when she goes in, she says 'Frannie' tries to kick at her. She said, 'You've got them spoiled. They don't want anyone in there but you.' I guess I do spoil them."

Chosen as the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association Outstanding Groom for 2021, Gibson, who has worked the past 14 years in the barn of trainer Kim Dailey, has taken care of some of the sport's most distinguished pacers and trotters.

That list would include multiple stakes winners and champions Test of Faith, When Dovescry and Allywag Hanover.

"When those opportunities came, I was so honored. I do my best to make sure every horse is cared for 100 per cent, and it was no different with these horses. It meant a lot to me that the trainers respected me enough to look after them ahead of big races. These are very talented animals, and I appreciated the chance I had to spend with them."

Gibson has a long association with horses and horse racing dating back to his childhood years.

"I was pretty much raised in the sport. My dad was into the horses, my mom was into the horses, and my stepdad was involved with the horses too. I think I was around eight when I jogged my first horse, so I've been around it for quite a long time."

After he finished high school, Gibson began working as a groom for Eric and Seldon Ledford.

It was an ideal place to launch his own career.

"I worked with them for about 12 years, before they went out east. I was with them when they went to Chicago, Indiana, but when they made the decision to go back to Chicago, I really didn't want to go back. I ended up meeting a trainer by the name of Gary Budahn from Indiana. I ended up working with him for quite a while. I went to California with him, and it ended up being a pretty fun ride with him. Going out to California was amazing. Right after Hoosier closed, back then it was around October, he would give his horses a couple months off and at the start of the year, he would send them to Del Mar to train and then they would race at Sacramento."

Although he enjoyed the opportunity to experience racing in different states and locales, Gibson began to miss the familiar surroundings of home.

“You have to love it. Some people understand it, some people don’t. It’s seven days a week. When I was travelling, I missed a lot of family stuff, but moving back home and working for Bill and Kim – they took me in as family – so I’ve been blessed. And to be able to work with these horses is the greatest thing.”

It was around 15 years ago when he made the decision to return to the Buckeye State.

“I missed my family and I wanted to come back to Ohio. I ended up finding work with a trainer for a little bit before I landed a job with Kim and Bill Dailey. I’ve been there ever since.”

It’s a place, offered Gibson, that feels just like home.

He’s had the chance to work closely with several talented types over the years, a list that includes a well-traveled trotter who earned \$377,090 over a career that yielded 30 wins and 87 top-three finishes from 202 starts.

“This horse, he is one of my favorite horses that I ever took care of. Kathy Ratcliff and Jerry Zosel bred and raced him. I had this horse ever since he was a baby. I don’t know what it was, but there was just something about him. He was special. I called him “Spider,” and we just connected right away.”

There have been others.

“Each one is memorable in their own way, but there are some that you recall more. I took care of Rose Run Spanky when he was 2 and won a Sires Stakes championship. Mystical Treasure, she set a track record at Scioto Downs, in 1:49.4. Rockathon, when he was 3, he was second in a Sires Stakes at Scioto, and he won at Delaware. When Bill passed away in May 2018, Kim and I raced Rockathon during his 3-year-old season and he ended up finishing second to Lather Up in the [\$275,000] Ohio Sires Stakes final at Scioto. That was a pretty big moment.”

Win or lose, Gibson, the last of the Bill Dailey Stable grooms, can’t envision doing anything else.

It’s a demanding life, but the rewards far outweigh the sacrifices that come with the role and responsibilities.

“You have to love it. Some people understand it, some people don’t. It’s seven days a week. When I was travelling, I missed a lot of family stuff, but moving back home and working for Bill and Kim – they took me in as family – so I’ve been blessed. And to be able to work with these horses is the greatest thing. Breaking them as babies, seeing them progress and then making it to the races, it always is that same feeling of pride and happiness to see them do that. You train them down, then it’s the first qualifier and then you see them race... that’s what I love about my job. You see all that hard work and it makes you realize you accomplished something.”

For Gibson, there is always something to look forward to every morning he walks into the barn.

Although the duties he’s tasked with him remain the same, each day is different from the next, something Gibson is reminded of each day he makes the drive to work.

“Being around the horse is the greatest feeling. Especially when you see the babies. From one day to the next, they are going to be doing something different. We are pretty lucky to have some really nice young horses, so it will be nice to be able to help them along their journey to the races.”

When he’s not at the racetrack or stables, Gibson gets in as much family time as possible.

Coming back to Ohio has afforded him with an ideal life, personally and professionally, a perfect recipe for happiness and contentment.

“It’s all about family for me. If I’m not with them, there is always something to do around home because you’re working seven days a week and racing five days. With such a busy work schedule, you appreciate any time you have to do what you want. Mostly, it’s spending time with family. I’m very fortunate that everyone understands what I do and that I might not always be there for certain moments. They know what the horse business is about. Some families might be upset if you miss a birthday party, but my family understands, and they know how much I love it.”

A love that only continues to grow.

“I really do love the horses and this sport. I feel lucky in so many ways. Once you get these horses in your blood, it’s impossible to even imagine not being around them.”

Slot races the shot in the arm racing needed

Slot races are polarizing.

But there is no doubting their rapid emergence in Down Under harness racing has been the shot in the arm the industry needed.

What's unquestionable is slot races have done three crucial things: created more, much-needed aspirational races; boosted the talkability of harness racing both inside and outside of the industry itself; and stirred the wealthiest people in the game to throw significantly more money into it.

There will be three harness slot races across Australia and New Zealand in 2023 – two of them run for the first time.

The trailblazer was NZ's "Race by Grins", which was run for the first time in April this year and proved hugely successful despite the host club, Cambridge, having to basically "fly solo" to make it happen, with little help from the broader NZ harness industry.

The old "build it and they will come" motto has proven somewhat true with Harness Racing NZ showing far greater "love" for next year's second-running of The Race by Grins and even kicking in some extra prize money to take it from \$NZ900,000 to \$NZ1 million.

"We were thrilled with the first year," Cambridge CEO Dave Branch said. "Slot holders, owners, trainers and drivers really embraced it... from Australia as well as NZ."

NZ's leading media commentator Michael Guerin predicted The Race by Grins could quickly become NZ's most sought-after harness race, usurping the great NZ Cup in November, which has stagnant prize money and will increasingly struggle to get consistent and strong Australian participation given how close its run in the calendar to the Inter Dominion.

"It falls in a good spot on the Aussie calendar and getting a few Aussies across for it, which Dave (Branch) and the team at Cambridge did so well last year, is crucial to take the race to another level," he said.

Entain (Ladbrokes) has locked Magnificent Storm in for its slot in the Nullarbor.

Already, the connections of arguably Australia's best pacer Rock N Roll Doo have declared their intention to chase the Race by Grins next year.

And global wagering giant Entain, through its Ladbrokes brand, have snapped up Rock N Roll Doo to race for their slot.

That's a huge "get" because things have changed since Cambridge locked in its April 14 time slot for 2023.

As only harness racing could do, for one of the new slot races, the \$A1 million Nullarbor at Perth's Gloucester Park, will be run on exactly the same night.

Yes, harness racing Down Under is pretty good at shooting itself in the foot.

In defence of those behind the Perth race, their timing was part of a broader strategic play and was in no way a direct attack on the NZ race.

The Western Australian racing industry body, Racing and Wagering Western Australia, announced slot races for all three racing codes in WA – gallops, harness and greyhounds – and wanted them all run on the same weekend – April 14 and 15.

So, the harness and greyhound (Sandgroper) races will be on Friday night and the \$A4 million thoroughbred equivalent (the

Quokka) will be run the following afternoon at Ascot racetrack.

"We opted for NZ for a couple of reasons," Rock N Roll Doo's trainer/driver Michael Stanley said. "It might sound strange, but it's a lot easier to get flights to and from Auckland than it is Perth."

"And the Gloucester Park is small (half-mile) and we don't think Rock N Roll Doo would handle it overly well."

"Plus, we took him across to NZ for the Cup in early November and he handled the trip well."

So, what does Stanley think of the slot races?

"Great, why wouldn't they be? Anything that gets people talking and writing out the sport the better," he said. "It's added another dimension with our horse, first deciding which race to target and then negotiating with slot holders for the right fit."

"There was a lot of interest in Rock N Roll Doo. It's great to see others think as much of him as we do."

Rob Tomlinson, managing owner of WA's best pacer Magnificent Storm, echoed Stanley's comments.

"We're thrilled they've launched the Nullarbor over here. It's perfect timing for us with a horse like Magnificent Storm right at the peak of his career," he said.

“There’s been a void in the calendar around that April/May time and to have a \$A1 million race here in our backyard and not have to travel to chase it is fantastic.

“My company actually bought a slot in the race and originally planned to run Magnificent Storm in that slot, but there was so much interest in him and some attractive offers, we did an outside deal.”

Like Rock N Roll Doo, Entain (Ladbrokes) has locked Magnificent Storm in for its slot in the Nullarbor.

The “king” of slot races in Australasia is the TAB Eureka, but it’s not run until Sept. 2 and is very different to the Race by Grins and Nullarbor.

The TAB Eureka is restricted to 3- and 4-year-old pacers only and they must be Australian-bred. It is unashamedly designed to try and boost the Australian breeding industry and build domestic stallions.

A large slice of its funding comes from international stallion levies, impacting NZ and North Americans.

That’s been quite controversial, but the fact it’s been so well embraced by owners, trainers and drivers has largely negated that.

Having the world’s richest race at \$A2.1 million is quite a tag.

Ever since the race was formally launched last year, talk has been rampant about which slot holders will snare the most sought-after pacers, headed by the freakish 4-year-old Captain Ravishing and last year’s triple Derby winner Leap To Fame.

And that’s just what Harness Racing Australia’s CEO Andrew Kelly wanted.

“We want this race to be talked about 24 hours a day, seven days a week and 365 days a year,” he said. “It’s been a great start and it’ll only build even more as the month’s tick down towards the first running.”

Woodbine Mohawk Park wraps up record 2022 season

As the final hours and minutes ticked away for 2022, Woodbine Mohawk Park contested its final race card of another successful live racing season on Saturday night (Dec. 31).

Woodbine announced earlier in December that all-sources wagering for 2022 at Woodbine Mohawk Park had surpassed \$400 million, blowing by the previous high of \$364 million in 2019.

Saturday's season finale card featured 10 races, including a \$34,000 preferred pace.

Saulsbrook Victor just got up the inside of co-favorite So Much More in the final strides to secure his first Woodbine preferred victory in 1:52. Austin Sorrie guided the 4-year-old to victory for trainer Ron MacDonald and owner Brett MacDonald. Saturday's score was the sixth win in 38 starts this season and pushed his seasonal earnings over \$150,000.

The preferred win was one of three for driver Sorrie on Saturday. The titles of leading driver, trainer and owner were well wrapped up ahead of Saturday's season finale.

Despite being held off the board Saturday, reinsman James MacDonald finished his incredible 2022 season as the top driver with 400 wins. MacDonald became just the fifth driver in Woodbine Entertainment history to win 400 or more races in a single year.

The last driver to surpass 400 wins in a year was James' brother, Mark MacDonald, who won 404 in 2006. Prior to the MacDonald brothers, Randy Waples (430 in 2001), Chris Christoforou (407 in 2000) and Doug Brown (416 in 1995 and 412 in 1994) were the only other drivers to accomplish the feat.

The 2022 Woodbine driving title is the second consecutive for James MacDonald.

Trainer Richard Moreau and owner Brad Grant once again led in victories for their respective divisions. Moreau now has seven

consecutive Woodbine leading trainer titles and 11 overall for his career. Grant also picks up his seventh straight Woodbine leading owner title.

MacDonald, Moreau and Grant received their awards on Monday evening (Jan. 2).

Forbidden Trade retired to stud in Ontario

The 2019 Hambletonian champion and Canadian Horse Of The Year, Forbidden Trade, has been retired to stud and is now accepting applications for the 2023 breeding season.

Determination's Serge Godin has said the multiple O'Brien Award winner, who could possibly capture the fourth O'Brien of his career early next month, will be standing at Deerpath Breeding & Development in Ontario, just five minutes from Classy Lane Training Centre, and the same facility that collected world champion Bulldog Hanover during the 2022 breeding season. Forbidden Trade's stallion career will be managed by Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky, formerly of Hanover Shoe Farms.

When asked about her new role managing his career as a sire, Jablonsky said, "Forbidden Trade is an exceptional individual. He's a Hambletonian champion, and in winning that race he defeated the horse who I believe to be the fastest trotter to ever look through a bridle – Greenshoe. He's a multiple O'Brien Award winner and a Dan Patch Award winner, that's by an O'Brien and Dan Patch winner [Kadabra] and out of an O'Brien winner [Pure Ivory]. That's not the kind of opportunity that presents itself to breeders very often."

Forbidden Trade [3,1:51; \$2,364,825] won 15 of 25 starts at ages 2 and 3 for Determination, trainer Luc Blais and driver Bob McClure, earning more than \$1.3 million over that same time span and bringing home three O'Brien Awards as well – including the Somebeachsomewhere Horse Of The Year honor following his 3-year-old, Hambletonian-winning season. His 4-year-old year was shortened to just five starts due to injury, but he came back as strong as ever at age 5, earning more than \$630,000 as well as the Dan Patch Award as top Older Male Trotter in the U.S. In 2022, at age 6, he won four more times and added just shy of a quarter-million dollars more to his career bankroll, earning another O'Brien Award nomination in the process.

Forbidden Trade will stand for a service fee of \$7,000 U.S. for the first mare, and just \$3,500 U.S. each for every mare thereafter with the same ownership. All foals will be eligible to the Ontario Sires Stakes program as well as the Breeders Crown.

Don Irvine, Jr. elected to the Ohio Hall of Fame

Driver Donald Irvine, Jr., winner of more than 7,600 races, has been elected as the 49th member of the Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Fame by a vote of the members of the Ohio Chapter of the United States Harness Writers Association.

The Mt. Gilead, OH native exploded on the scene in the 1970's, dominating the driving ranks at Northfield Park and was greeted like a rock star on the Buckeye State's county fair circuit. Prominent owners and trainers competed for his catch driving services. His skills were eclectic: ratable on the engine, confident and quick from the pocket or a boxed-in traffic jam, or patiently timing a swoop from the back of the pack.

Irvine ruled Northfield Park through most of the '80s, scoring 269 times in 1982 to rank among North America's best. He followed that up in '83 and '84 to be among the top 25 on the dash/winning leaderboards.

In 1988, with more than 20 meet driving championships under his belt at Northfield, "Junior" migrated to Maryland and its highly competitive but insular driving colony in the Baltimore/D.C. area. He quickly took them to school, finishing first in both money won and UDR at Freestate Raceway's premier summer meet. He repeated those feats there in 1989, and for good measure, did the same at Rosecroft's 45-day fall meet. Don also set a record that session for most wins – six – on a single card. His 354 total wins in 1989 ranked him 11th in North America while his purse earnings just over \$2 million placed him 25th.

A 1991 inductee on Northfield Park's Wall of Fame, Irvine returned to his home track in 1992 and quickly took charge.

He was tops in all three categories with 347 wins, a .345 UDR and \$1.0 million in earnings, the first Ohio driver to reach the million-dollar threshold in a single season.

The itinerant veteran continued his winning ways in neighboring Indiana, capturing six additional driving titles at Hoosier Park in the 1990's and 2000's.

Over the last decade and a half, the prolific baby boomer has tapped the brakes a bit as he glided into Social Security status. Still, his stats are impressive over that time period: 8,603 starts and \$8.3 million in earnings.

Irvine will be honored at the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association's annual banquet on Saturday, Jan. 14 at the Polaris Hilton in Columbus.

Yonkers 2023 season starts Jan. 16

Live racing will take place on a Monday through Friday basis from the start of the 2023 season through the end of April. Starting in May, Wednesday will become a dark day and live racing will move to a Monday-Tuesday-Thursday-Friday-Saturday

schedule until October when the Monday-Friday slate resumes and Saturday switches back to a dark day. Yonkers will not hold any programs from Wednesday, Nov. 22 through Friday, Nov. 24 for Thanksgiving.

The MGM Borgata Pacing Series for free-for-allers will get going on Monday, March 20, with five preliminary legs set to take place. The finals for both the MGM Borgata Pacing Series and the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series for pacing mares will be held on Monday, April 24.

The first legs of the Trotting and Pacing Triple Crowns, the MGM Yonkers Trot and MGM Grand Messenger Stakes, will see their finals occur on Friday, June 30, with the purse for the MGM Yonkers Trot guaranteed at \$300,000 and the MGM Grand Messenger offering an estimated purse of \$250,000. A major change of note for those looking to enter either race, the total starting fee for the elimination and final is now just \$3,000, down from \$7,500 (\$5,000 elim, \$2,500 final). The supplemental fee was also reduced from \$30,000 to \$25,000.

On Saturday, Sept. 9, New York Night of Champions will return to Yonkers Raceway, as the best horses in the Empire State are crowned in eight sire stakes finals. Yonkers will also play host to New York Sire Stakes legs throughout 2023, with further details to come once that schedule is finalized.

Last, but certainly not least, the world's best trotters will come to Yonkers Raceway on that above-mentioned date of Saturday, September 23, for the \$1 million MGM Yonkers International Trot. That program has a scheduled post time of noon (eastern).

Tetrick wins both Philly driving titles; Engblom, Alagna top trainers

He may not have posted a track-record-tying ten winners as he did on the last day of racing at Harrah's Philadelphia in 2021, but on Philly's last 2022 card Tim Tetrick put the finishing touches on an outstanding local season during which he captured the dash and UDR titles.

Tetrick added five victories on closing day to his seasonal haul (tying second-place Simon Allard for the day's honors), and added three seconds and four thirds while driving in all fifteen races. This brought his seasonal scorecard to 1005 258-195-122-.405, good enough to give him his eighth dash championship at the southeast Pennsylvania oval, and his ninth UDR crown in the track's seventeen years of existence.

On the training side, Per Engblom harnessed 75 winners to earn his first Philly championship. In the UTR chase, Tony Alagna, who had no entrants on the final card, not only took top honors for the first time, but he did it with a log of 89-32-18-10, the resultant .509 percentage being the highest single-season total ever recorded locally.

Dayton closes on successful meet; Smith, Brewer take titles

Unusually warm weather and fast track conditions helped close the curtain on the ninth racing season at Hollywood Gaming at Dayton Raceway on Friday (Dec. 30).

After 70 race days, the 2022 live meet concluded as Dayton Raceway's most successful. Not only did the southwest Ohio track play host to the richest card in the state's racing history, but overall handle increased by \$3.4 million in comparison to 2021. Four of the top five single card handles occurred during this year's meet. The all-time daily handle record was broken on Oct. 1 when \$1.2 million was wagered on the Hollywood Dayton program.

"We had an excellent meet," said director of racing Jason Bluhm. "We have horsemen to thank for that. Nearly every card was at capacity. Quality horses and full boxes only help handle."

Bluhm went on to credit race secretary Gregg Keidel and the entire Dayton Raceway team for their hard work this season.

Awards were also presented to both the meet's leading driver and trainer.

Jeremy Smith was named the 2022 leading driver. In less than 730 starts, Smith tallied 149 wins and earned more than \$1.2 million in purses. Alongside being in the money 49% of his starts, the 42-year-old driver maintained a .331 UDRS. To add to his impressive stats, Smith earned the title with an impressive 40-win lead over his competitors.

The title of 2022 leading trainer was awarded to Jason Brewer. After sending 282 starters behind the gate, Brewer scored 45 wins, 47 second place finishes, and 47 third place finishes. His horses earned over \$546,000 in purse monies. Brewer's father, Jeff, captured the training title in two previous years – making them the first father-son duo to take the honor.

Keystone USHWA announces 2022 honorees

C. Edward (Ed) Rogers Jr., approaching his 20th year of overseeing harness racing serving on the Pennsylvania Commission, has been voted the Mary Lib Miller Award, the highest award given by the Keystone Chapter of the U.S. Harness Writers Association (USHWA). The award is named in honor of the hard-working and supportive wife of national Hall Of Famer Delvin Miller, "Harness Racing's Ambassador."

Rogers, a graduate of Lebanon Valley College (PA) with a degree in Economics and Business Administration who later earned his CPA certificate, first became associated with harness racing through a job as auditor of The Telegraph Press, parent company of the Harness Horse magazine. Pennsylvania Harness Hall of Famer Bowman Brown Sr. asked him to serve as a cashier at the famous Harrisburg sale, and as his accounting career expanded in responsibility, so grew his interest in harness racing.

Rogers was first named to the then Pennsylvania Harness Racing Commission in 1995, and upon a reorganization to the Pennsylvania State Horse Commission overseeing both sports, has served that organization since 2016. Always an advocate for prudence and even-handedness, with an unusual eye towards the needs of harness racing's fans, Rogers holds such "firsts" as being the "father" of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Fair Championships and in 2006 being the first person ever to jog a horse over the new Harrah's racetrack in the southeast part of the state.

The Keystone Chapter of USHWA is also honoring other outstanding contributors to harness racing in the state, all to be feted at the USTA District 7 / Fair Banquet on Saturday, Jan. 19 at the Graduate State College Hotel.

Three 3-year-old pacers, one colt and two fillies, are to be honored. The colt is Fourever Boy, a son of Sweet Lou owned by Micki Rae Stables LLC in partnership with trainer Tim Twaddle. Fourever Boy is being recognized as the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes pari-mutuel male performer of the year after a win and a second in PASS prelims, and then a 1:49.1 victory in his Championship. Fourever Boy also made his presence on the national scene, especially in the Little Brown Jug, where he won an elimination and was second in the final; he also made the final of the Breeders Crown, Meadowlands Pace, North America Cup, Adios, and Progress Pace.

Fourever Boy's filly counterpart in the p/m Sire Stakes category is Captain Cowgirl, a daughter of Captaintreacherous who became the first pacer ever, male or female, to win her PASS preliminary point title and then her Championship at both ages 2 and 3. Owned by Jo Ann Looney-King and Kenneth Freider (Tim Tetrack

LLC also owned a share during a portion of her freshman year), Captain Cowgirl also made history by winning \$265,374 in Sire Stakes racing alone during 2022, the most ever by a 3-year-old of either gait or either sex.

The other pacing filly is Bettor Strait N Up, earning a Special Recognition Award. She paralleled Captain Cowgirl in winning both her point titles at the fairs and then her Championship at both 2 and 3, and she is the very first Fair horse to turn the trick, regardless of sex or gait. Owned throughout her fair campaigns by driver Tony and trainer Linda Schadel, the Betting Line filly won \$99,870 racing in the Fair Sire Stakes program – and also managed to pay \$24.40 for \$2 while winning her sophomore Championship this past October!

Mitchell York was lauded as the trainer of the Pennsylvania Small Stable of the Year. A retired Pennsylvania State Trooper of 25 years' service, York took up harness racing working with his father-in-law, long-time Keystone stalwart Dave Brickell, and while a full-time trainer now for only three years, York's trainees earned just over \$500,000 in 2022 in only 179 starts. His top horses include Annapolis Hanover, a freshman pacer who won two PASS pari-mutuel races and was second in his final; Little Lady J, a two-year-old filly whose 1:57.4 at Gratz made her the fastest horse in her division all-time at any Pennsylvania fair; and two-year-old trotter Ab Fab Hanover, his fair division's leading point-winner.

Ashley Eisenbeil and Dawnelle Mock, two tireless and upbeat workers for the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Association, are being honored as the Keystone Chapter/USHWA's members of the year.

Eisenbeil spent seven years as senior manager for hospitality and Preakness Ticket Sales for the Maryland Jockey Club. She then shifted her work to her native Pennsylvania in the spring of 2017, first as the director of marketing for the Pennsylvania State Horse Racing Commission, which oversees the furthering of the two racing breeds in the Keystone State, and then in the same role for the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Association, a group of industry stakeholders. With social media a special emphasis of her work, Eisenbeil works with both the present and next generation of fans to keep them informed about and attract them to the dynamic world of PA racing.

Mock, a 2019 winner of the Breakthrough Award from national USHWA, once had a story about her start like this: "Once upon a time, there was a little girl who loved horses, and she took that love of horses and made it into a successful career." Mock spent several years as the marketing director for the Meadows Standardbred Owners Association, representing the horsemen at the Pittsburgh-area track, promoting both The Meadows signature Adios Pace while at the same time going "full circle" with fun promotions such as Wiener Dog Racing. Mock recently joined the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Association as Director of Digital Content.

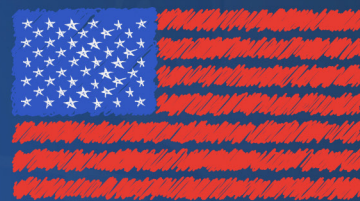

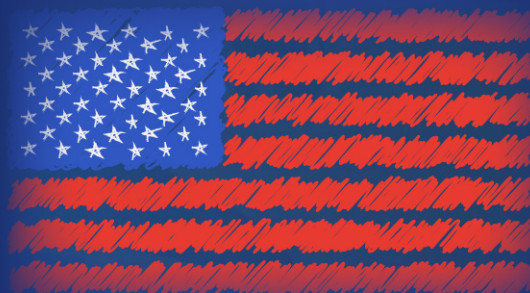
