Disgraced veterinarian Louis Grasso can't seem to stay out of trouble.

Just 18 days before he was set to begin a 50-month prison sentence for selling performance-enhancing drugs, Grasso was arraigned in a Pennsylvania court on Jan. 6 after authorities charged that he conspired with a casino employee in a scheme that netted Grasso \$21,646.

According to a story in the *Times Leader*, Grasso, 66, and electronic craps dealer Jason Kutney worked together to rig an electronic craps game. Kutney was responsible for pushing a button at the end of a 30-second clock allowing patrons to place bets. But Kutney allegedly pushed the button early which allowed Grasso to see the outcome of the roll of the electronic dice before placing his bets.

According to court records, Grasso won \$17,521 on Dec. 30 at the machine manned by Kutney and another \$4,125 on Jan. 5. Security officials at the casino launched an investigation after realizing that players at Kutney's table were showing an unusually high win rate. According to the *Times Leader*, Kutney admitted to pushing the button on the machine earlier than when he should have.

According to the website **casino.org**, surveillance video showed Kutney hitting the button early nine times. That, the website

reported, gave patrons as much as 20 seconds to place their bets even though the dice had already been rolled and the winning numbers had already been displayed.

According to casino.org, Kutney was charged with three felony charges for receiving stolen property, theft by unlawful taking, and conspiring to trick, fraud, or manipulate a casino. Kutney has also been hit with a first-degree misdemeanor for knowingly tricking and/or defrauding a business. The website did not report what charges were being brought against Grasso, but it is believed that they are similar to the charges pending against Kutney.

Grasso is due to appear in Luzerne County Court next on Jan. 17 for a preliminary hearing on the casino charges.

In November, Grasso, a veterinarian who worked in the harness racing industry and was one of more than two dozen individuals indicted in 2020 for their role in a horse doping ring, was sentenced after pleading guilty to one count of drug adulteration and misbranding conspiracy, a felony. The prosecution had maintained that Grasso's doping led to corrupt trainers collecting over \$47 million in ill-gotten purse winnings.

In May, when Grasso entered a guilty plea, the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District Court issued a press release in which U.S. Attorney Damian Williams commented on the Grasso plea as well as the guilty plea entered by harness trainer Richard Banca. Banca was sentenced to 30 months.

"Grasso and Banca represent the corruption and greed of those in the racehorse industry looking to win at any cost," Williams said. "In peddling illegal drugs and selling prescriptions to corrupt trainers, Louis Grasso abdicated his responsibilities as a medical professional to ensure the safety and health of the racehorses he 'treated.' By injecting horses with unnecessary and, at times, unknown drugs, Grasso risked the lives and welfare of the animals under his care, all in service of helping corrupt racehorse trainers like Banca line their pockets through fraud. These latest convictions demonstrate the commitment of this Office and of our partners at the FBI to hold accountable individuals seeking to profit from animal abuse and deceit."

Prior to his sentencing, Grasso wrote a letter to the judge asking for leniency because of health issues and his modest financial means.

"I am a physical wreck," Grasso wrote. "I am not a rich man. I don't have much in the way of money or possessions. I have no savings, I have little cash available... While I don't live hand to mouth, I don't have the ability to withstand any catastrophic events in my life."

Is the return of stallions to the track the start of a trend?

This past month has seen the return to the track of two stallions, both prominent former racehorses. A Breeders Crown winner and 3-year-old standout in 2016, Racing Hill first returned in a qualifier in December, and the O'Brien award-winning 2-year-old from 2018 Stag Party made his pari-mutuel return last week. Now age 10, Racing Hill will have a 7-year gap in between starts when he goes into an actual race, and Stag Party who is now 7

years of age, showed just over a three-year gap when he raced last week at the Meadowlands.

Though horses in these instances returning to the races following time away at stud is certainly still the exception rather than the norm, perhaps what we're seeing is the start of a growing trend. These two horses immediately followed **Jimmy Freight** as another top performing racehorse who returned to the track after a period of being away as a sire. In the case of Jimmy Freight, his time away from the track was much shorter than Racing Hill and Stag Party – and his reasons for returning were different as well – but it shows there is reason for lesser hesitancy in bringing horses back into training than had been prior.

If horses can safely and ethically transition back into their first career as a racehorse and race somewhat relative to their former capabilities adjusted for age, then why not. If anything, it continues to speak to the durability and resilience of the standardbred breed.

In the case of Jimmy Freight and even going back a few years further to the 2012 Hambletonian winner Market Share as another example, fertility issues ultimately proved as reasons to bring those horses back to the track. But in other instances, it may simply be a matter of economics, which was the case for Stag Party.



Casie Coleman trained Stag Party when he raced in his career through ages 2 and 3 and remains part of the ownership group today. In explaining the thought process for what led to Stag Party's return, Coleman said, "His oldest foals just turned 2 so they're in training now. They look good and I'm hearing good reviews, but the thing is that he hasn't gotten that good of a chance to breed a lot of mares, especially this past year. The first year wasn't terrible at how many mares he bred, but that number has declined and last year he didn't breed that many at all."

This past year at Harrisburg, yearlings for Stag Party averaged \$15,000. That number may not seem awful, but as a reflection of the small number of mares he bred, there were only a total of six offerings. For Coleman, she noted that this is the first time she's been part of bringing a horse back into racing that had been retired to stud.

"He's going to have three or four crops on the ground and people are going to wait and see how those horses race. This year at stud would have been very difficult because the mares will go to all the new sires coming up, and we'll have to wait and see how his foals do on the track. He was always a sound horse, and it was Eric Cherry who is a part-owner on him, that also suggested that we put him back into training. I said I'll go along for the ride with whatever decisions the group wanted to make, and so we put him back into racing and we'll see what happens."

Maybe it's still too early to declare Racing Hill and Stag Party returning on the heels of Jimmy Freight returning as a trend, but what is becoming more common is the concept here in North America of horses showing that they can both breed and race at the same time.

In the past couple of seasons, Bulldog Hanover, Catch The Fire and Cattlewash come to mind as horses that have conducted full breeding seasons and then raced successfully. In 2022, in addition to all his on-track accolades that now belong in harness racing lore, Bulldog Hanover bred 79 mares. In 2021, Catch The Fire bred 86 mares – the same year that he won the Sam McKee Memorial and Dan Patch Invitational in back-to-back races. Ditto for Cattlewash, who in 2021 stood for a breeding season and


nearly concurrently won the Graduate, William Haughton and was runner-up in the Breeders Crown.

As these horses show they're able to perform double duty as a stallion and racehorse or are able to resume their career on-track after (even extended) periods away, it could lead others to follow suit. Not every horse will necessarily make a great stallion, and the economics of harness racing still certainly allow for different fits to maximize different revenue streams for each horse. It also allows for the horse to go back to doing perhaps what it's actually happiest doing.

If things don't pan out as intended for any of the horses either performing double duty or returning back to the track, you'd think that because of the higher profile nature of them, that these horses would be retired gracefully (such was the case with Market Share after a brief attempt to return with him as a gelding) rather than what is seen in plenty of other former warhorses now toiling around in lower levels throughout smaller racing circles.

The return of these former stars will be watched closely, as how they perform may influence others in their decisions to retire, race or stand their horses, or both.





Gural key in pushing amendments to Horseracing Integrity and Security Act now signed into law

At the end of December, U.S. President Joe Biden signed a revised Horseracing Integrity and Safety Act (HISA) into law as part of a \$1.7 trillion omnibus spending bill.

The move came after lawmakers in Congress made changes to the bill to repair provisions of HISA that a federal appellate court deemed unconstitutional in November.

An article on Augustafreepress.com said Meadowlands owner Jeff Gural, Animal Wellness Action and the Jockey Club "were instrumental in passage of the amendment."


Gural has strong political connections, especially to former Speaker of the House Nancy Pelosi.


"We applaud the Congress for making the statutory fix to remedy a legal concern that came from a federal appellate court," said Animal Wellness Action executive director Marty Irby in a press release. "But it wasn't without a fight, and it's hard to believe that horsemen and even some politicians are fighting to preserve race-day doping in thoroughbred racing in America. Their work puts horses and jockeys at risk and scrambles the results for gamblers and other fans of the sport."

The Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority created by the legislation will be overseen by the Federal Trade Commission.

The bill also provides a record \$4.1 million in funding to enforce the Horse Protection Act (HPA) of 1970 for the 2023 fiscal year. Part of that includes continuing the ban on horse slaughter on U.S. soil. That funding is six times more than the HPA received in 2018.

HISA was originally signed into law by former President Donald Trump in 2020 and was originally expected to go into effect in July 2022. Its implementation was halted when attorneys for a long list of Horsemen's Benevolent Protective Association groups and many more successfully argued before the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit that HISA, as then constructed, was unconstitutional.

Alberta's Kelly Crump on trying to improve on his terrific second season as a trainer

Kelly Crump made the decision to go from farm to stable.

Before he joined the world of standardbred racing on a full-time scale, the man from Standard, AB, a village about a 50-mile drive east of Calgary, worked in the agriculture industry.

But when the opportunity to become a full-fledged horse trainer came his way, Crump didn't have to field a plan to make the career move.

Racing found him.

"I kind of fell into it a couple of years ago. Dad [trainer/driver, Stephen] was getting his knees done and I was in a job transfer at the time, and the next thing you know, about a year and a half later, he said, 'I'm out!' so he left me a bunch of horses. That's how I ended up getting started. I had a few owners come on and it just kind of snowballed from there. My brother Kyle phoned me about a horse, and it ended up that we bought a

horse named Blue Star Mystic. That's how he started out as an owner. He bought another one and then he got a friend involved and they bought another one... it went from me having three or four horses a year ago to having 16 in the barn right now."

The Crump clan is no stranger to the racing game.

A connection to the sport and its stars dates back decades for the family, well before Kelly landed his first full-time job.

"We raced horses when I was a kid, probably up until I was about 20, and then we got out of it. About 2004, mom and dad, they both had full-time jobs, they wanted to get back into it a little more. They bought in on a couple and when I was working in the agriculture industry, I really got interested in the breeding side of horse racing. We ended up buying a stallion for our mares. That's how I really started in it, studying the pedigrees and the breeding."

Kelly posted one third from four starts in 2019 and posted one win in nine races the following year, before going all-in for the 2021 season.

It proved to be a solid rookie campaign, one that produced seven wins and 21 top-three finishes from 46 starts.

The past season, however, was even more memorable, punctuated by 48 wins and \$277,412 in purse earnings, along with a .376 UTRS.

"I have to say it was a hell of a year," Kelly said with a laugh.

One of the most significant contributors to his big year was the willingness to learn as much as he could from more seasoned horsepeople.

"I just listened. That's the biggest thing. There are a lot of good people in this industry. Dave Kelly, Logan Gills, Ryan Grundy, Joey Ratchford... I came in knowing very little and people like them have been in it for a long, long time. They are easy to talk to and share information, which is a really helpful thing for a quy like me who is just starting out."

There were also some welcome fatherly words of wisdom Kelly received.

A specific piece of advice has become extremely helpful in the way he manages his stable.

"One thing from dad, something that I wanted to take from him, was to give a horse a break when they need it. It was all about good horsemanship. I look at it this way, that your horses will do well for you if they are happy and healthy. You will run out of conditions because that is just the way it is, but as long as you know when to shut a horse down, to make sure they are sound and happy, that will go a long way. They aren't machines and they deserve your respect and care. Dad shod his own horses and I do a bunch of shoeing, but there are some that require a more detailed and specialized type of care, so I get some of the other farriers to help me in those situations."

A horse by the name of BJS Bequia has been a difference maker for Kelly.

His penchant for breeding eventually led him to the now 16-year-old son of Rocknroll Hanover—Plant A Kiss, an original \$32,000 purchase (Hip No. 121) at the 2008 Harrisburg Sale.

"This is when I was still working in the agriculture industry. I was looking around the Internet and I was looking for a Somebeachsomewhere stud, but they are so hard to get. I always liked the Rocknroll Hanover line – they are purse racehorses – and I saw this stud was still racing. At that time, he had around 297 starts, and over \$700,000 in earnings and he had done it all the hard way. I phoned the guy who owned him and another guy from Ontario went down to look at him. I told him, 'Don't buy him unless you give me a call first.' Well, he phoned me and told me that he was already on the trailer and if I didn't want him, he'd take him."

Kelly decided to keep BJS Bequia, one of many smart calls he's made so far in his young career.

It's also a reminder of why he's grateful to work with the horses and to compete against people he's already developed a deep respect for.

Are there any similarities between those who work in the agriculture and racing industries?

"I think the people. In both, people are always willing to help out, and take care of one another. I suppose you could say both industries have people who are salt of the earth types. Everyone is really friendly. There is the competitive side to the racing, but that comes with any sport."

These days, Kelly, along with a handful of other trainers based in Calgary, have made their way to Cal-Expo for their winter months.

It's not an unfamiliar place for the trainer, albeit in a different scenario this time.

"This is my first year going by myself. I came down with mom and dad six years ago. I came down for about five or six months. They had about 10 horses here. I miss some of the help I had back in Alberta. Some of your owners are here to help you and my girlfriend helps me paddock. You do get hired help and the hired help down here is fantastic."

Kelly is hoping that year three can be just as successful as 2022.

A trio of BJ Bequia colts, 3-year-olds Tin Can Timmy, Smokn Joe, and Shotgun Willie, have caught his attention.

"I have a lot of young stock out of my stallion. They are three now. I had a 2-year-old, Tin Can Timmy, who did really well last year. Seeing him continue on and having some of the other ones keep developing is what the goal is. Smokn Joe had a really solid first year too. We had another one, Shotgun Willie, who ended up getting a fracture in his foot and he needed about seven months off. I was about a week away from qualifying and he ended up taking a bad step. It is what it is. It's hard on your gut when they hurt themselves, but they are so resilient."

When the Cal-Expo season comes to a close, Kelly will head back to Alberta and ready himself and his band of pacers for the racing season there.

For now, he's looking to make the most of his time on and off the track in the Golden State.

"My girlfriend and I went to old Sacramento and had dinner there. We also went to a car museum, which was fun too. I went on a road trip with Ryan Grundy to see where the gold mines started in California. You have to get away from the racing to keep your mind happy. You have to find things to enjoy. Whether that's snowboarding, skiing, golfing, it's just nice to escape for a little while."





Sunday Funday

The Big M is experimenting with a couple of Sunday afternoon cards in January.

Ask and you shall receive.

For the first time since May of 2016, The Meadowlands will be racing on Sunday afternoons, January 22 and 29, to be specific.

"The reason I wanted to try a couple of Sundays is I've had a lot of customers say things to me about Sunday afternoons where I've never really had anyone say anything about Thursday evenings," said Meadowlands' chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir.

Sundays were a fairly regular occurrence in the first few months of the year from 2008 to 2010, but since 2011, the year Jeff Gural acquired the track, there have been a total of two, one in 2011 and one in 2016.

"Jeff finally relented and said 'Okay, try Sunday afternoons," said Settlemoir. "Quite honestly, I've always wanted to try Sunday afternoons. I think they'll be better than Thursday evenings. And I wanted to be able to try different things with food and beverage. That's why we're doing the brunch. And I'm going to make my famous Bloody Marys, so that'll be fun."



The Sunday brunch buffet, that will include Settlemoir's spicy Bloody Mary, kicks off at 11:30 a.m. with post time for the special race cards at 12:30 p.m.

Race secretary Scott Warren has been dealing with a healthy entry box, resulting in 14-race cards every Friday and Saturday night since the end of the championship meet on Hambletonian Day. The two Thursday night cards, that took place on Sept. 1 and Dec. 1, each had nine races.

It's unclear at this point how many races will comprise each individual race card on the Friday and Saturday nights and Sunday afternoons, but should the box continue to be supported in the same fashion that it recently has been, the aim is to have 36 races over the three-day weekends.

Warren had 465 horses drop in last week, which resulted in 28 full 10-horse fields prior to scratches, with the same full fields scheduled for this weekend.

Many factors contribute to the current plethora of horses, including, but not limited to, Pompano Park being permanently closed and many neighboring tracks not being open yet this year.

Yonkers Raceway is scheduled to return from hiatus on Monday, Jan. 16, and therefore drew for the 16^{th} and 17^{th} on Wednesday, Jan. 11.

Warren conducted The Meadowlands' regular weekly double draw for Friday and Saturday this week and still had 445 horses drop in, even with Yonkers doing their draw the next day.

"For the same week a year ago, we had 313 in the box and Yonkers started a week earlier," said Warren. "I think we'll be OK."

With The Meadowlands having to cancel on New Year's Eve after one race with unsafe racing conditions due to horrendous fog, the regular competition cycle for some horses has been thrown out of whack and they're still trying to catch up.

Full fields contributed to a \$7,057,927 Big M weekend at the windows on Jan. 6-7. In all of 2022, the track only hit or bested the \$7-million mark twice, on Meadowlands Pace weekend and Hambletonian weekend. As a point of clarity, the Hambletonian Day card itself brought in over \$7 million.

Warren also pointed out that The Meadowlands has close to 50 horses in to qualify this week. Ten of which made their last start outside of North America.

If live afternoon harness racing and brunch isn't enough on its own to entice people to come to The Big M, there's the added attraction of the NFL.

Afternoon playoff games are scheduled for both Jan. 22 and 29, which were part of the equation for Settlemoir.

"On Thursday nights, it's tough to get people here and I just thought we could try Sunday afternoons and see if we can spark a little interest," said Settlemoir.

Mythical trotter Calgary Games was among the 18 horses expected to enter Prix de Belgique when this text was written on Wednesday (Jan. 11). Timo Nurmos' trotter has his chance to grab his spot in the big race on Jan. 29. A top-three finish this Sunday will secure Calgary Games' entry in the Prix d'Amérique.

Saturday's (Jan. 14) Prix de Croix for 5-year-old colts and mares over 2,850 meters has gathered a splendid field of trotters.

Thierry Duvaldestin-trained Idao de Tillard and Philippe Allaire's Callmethebreeze are the most merited horses. Idao de Tillard won the \$215,000 Criterium Continental in his previous performance and is ready for a start in Prix d'Amérique on Jan. 29.

PARIS STAKES ROUND-UP

The \$125,000 Prix Maurice de Gheest for 3-year-old colts was held at Vincennes, Paris, on Saturday (Jan. 7) afternoon and when it comes to big stakes races for young trotters, Philippe Allaire is often seen in the winner's podium after the races. This time he had **Koctel du Dain** (Boccador de Simm), paired with David Thomain to count on and Koctel du Dain was unstoppable from the lead while first choice Kamehameha crossed the finish line as runner up with plenty of power saved after a pocket trip.

The 3-year-old fillies battled in Sunday's (Jan. 8) \$125,000 Prix Gelinotte where Fabrice Souloy trained **Kalamity d'Heripre** proved to be the best after a quite tough trip. Franck Nivard drove Souloy's trotter and the first kilometer was spent three wide before Nivard pushed his horse to the lead with a half-mile to go in the 2,175 meters long race.

Kalamity d'Heripre held her challengers behind her on the stretch and won in a stakes record of 1:57.2 over 1.3 miles.

Allaire had the big favorite when the \$125,000 Prix Charles Tiercelin for 4-year-olds was on Sunday's card, but crop dominant Just A Gigolo couldn't defend himself when Alessandro Gocciadoro played his card right with **Don't Say Gar** (Varenne). Just A Gigolo was served a second-over trip and Franck Nivard opted to attack three wide before Vincennes' last turn as leader Jack Tonic seemed to have plenty of gas to use in front. With 600 meters remaining, Just A Gigolo landed outside the leader Jack Tonic, who defended himself well until he lost his gait 50 meters before the wire.

Far outside, from far behind in the field, Gocciadoro followed as third-fourth three wide in the last turn and his Don't Say Gar flew on Vincennes' home stretch. Just a few meters before the wire, the Italian bred 4-year-old was first and the performance was impressing.

Jean Luc Dersoir trained **Elite de Jiel** (Niky) was very eager in fourth over when the \$92,500 Prix de Lille was held at Vincennes the same day and some well-merited trotters showed up behind the gate when the race was on. Elite de Jiel, driven by Francois Lagadeuc, got the order to attack far outside as the stretch began and when Bepi Bi got room to speed on the inside when leader FairPlay d'Urzy went off stride at the top of the stretch, it seemed to be an impossible mission to reach the front horses. But Elite de Jiel's finish was something extra and the 9-year-old mare secured the win in a mile rate of 1:54.4 over 1.3 miles.



Yonkers Raceway's 2023 meet begins Monday

The 2023 racing season at Yonkers Raceway kicks off on Monday night (Jan. 16) with an 11-race program and some new surprises for bettors and on-track patrons.

A \$40,000 open handicap pace (race eight) is the feature on the card, and the headliner is Crunch Time A (post three, George Brennan/Nik Drennan). A 7-year-old gelding by Somebeachsomewhere, Crunch Time A is making his Yonkers debut after a four-for-four run over at the Meadowlands since being imported. He'll take on the likes of Nandolo N (post two, Jason Bartlett/Shane Tritton), who closed out last year with two straight victories in Westchester. Monday night's program also has a \$10,000 guaranteed pool in the Pick 5. A 50-cent base wager, the sequence begins in the fifth race.

Fans attending the races live on Monday will notice a new state-of-the-art tote board that was installed shortly before the conclusion of the 2022 season. The tote board, which should greatly improve the on-track experience, is also capable of showing live video and replays.

Yonkers will also unveil a new slanted starting gate in the hopes of improving the chances for outside horses and providing a more even start for the entire field. The old starting gate had a two-foot differential from posts one to eight, while the new gate is supposed to have an eight-foot differential.

The new gate is expected to arrive Wednesday and track officials will test it with horses from the backstretch prior to the first live card on Monday.

To start off 2023, Yonkers will conduct live racing on a Monday through Friday schedule with a new post time of 7 p.m. (EST).

The three-year membership for \$75 is a great deal, the one-year membership is \$35. The Sulky maximum benefit remains at \$4,500 and since the drivers own their own race bikes, it
