Industry handle showing steady growth

Spurred by pandemic momentum, some handle metrics even outpaced thoroughbred numbers from last year.

In 2021, amounts wagered on harness races conducted in the U.S. continued positive trends established during the re-emergence from shutdowns in 2020. While impacts from COVID-19 wreaked havoc for horsepeople in the U.S. industry in 2020 and in Canada both in 2020 and again this past year, handle has posted quite notable gains, relative to years immediately prior. It's a fascinating dynamic.

From the United States Trotting Association's economic indicators data for 2020, the handle on a per-race average was down 7 per cent from 2019 prior to the stoppage of racing in March 2020. Once racing resumed, the per-race metric was up 20 per cent for the remainder of the year. That remarkable pre-to-post shutdown swing held true in 2021, where the per-race handle average from 2021 to 2019 was up 18.42 per cent. The total amount wagered of over \$1.62 billion in the U.S. in 2021 was also up nearly 14 per cent when compared to 2019, the most recent year not dramatically impacted by a reduction in race dates.

For a better sense of what those numbers mean, the thoroughbred industry can be used as a reference point. Naturally, total handle of over \$12 billion in 2021 from that side of things dwarfed the total wagering amount posted on the harness side, but percentage wise the numbers are more interesting.

Harness racing outpaced the thoroughbreds in terms of the percentage change of total handle in 2021 over 2019. In data provided through Equibase, thoroughbreds showed a 10.74 per cent total wagering increase, but harness racing showed a 13.90 per cent total wagering increase over that same time. Similar findings can be seen at a more detailed level. The 18.42 per

cent per race average gain from harness racing in 2021 over 2019 is close to being on par with a calculated 19.44 per cent thoroughbred gain for the same metric over that period.

In 2021, of the \$1.62 billion wagered in harness racing, over \$279.9 million of that came from the Meadowlands alone, and in just 92 race days. With those figures provided to HRU, the Meadowlands accounted for 17.25 per cent of the total amount wagered on U.S. races, so it's not a surprise that their figures mirror the industry. And in some cases, metrics from that track have helped to buoy overall numbers. For example, total industry numbers show a per race average gain of 4.91 per cent from 2021 to 2020, while the Meadowlands shows a 13.75 per cent gain in average handle per card.

Not to be overlooked, there were smaller tracks that also built from the momentum established in the latter part of 2020 to go on and post record numbers in 2021. Tracks such as Harrah's Philadelphia and Hollywood Dayton are examples of ovals that not only smashed wagering volumes predictably from 2020, but those tracks went on to post total record handles in the 16-year and 7-year histories of the tracks, respectively.

Handle from Woodbine Mohawk Park in Ontario aren't included in the U.S. handle figures, obviously, though that track's success in 2021 aligns with trends seen in the U.S. data. Total handle at Woodbine Mohawk exceeded \$324 million last year, with average nightly handle topping the \$2 million dollar mark for the second consecutive year.

Where Woodbine Mohawk and other tracks across the province differed from their U.S. counterparts is in the number of race days in 2021. Whereas tracks in the U.S. were able to race unimpeded in 2021, Woodbine Mohawk was impacted by two separate government mandated stoppages last year and as a result they raced even fewer days than they did in 2020. But, just the same, their results were comparable to growth in daily handle seen in the U.S. Average nightly handle at Woodbine Mohawk slightly exceeded its 2020 total, but its 2021 average card handle of \$2.06 million easily bested the average handle of \$1.69 million from 2019.

It's easy to compare the numbers, but it's much more difficult to pinpoint the reasons for positive industry trends that go back even years prior to the pandemic.

In Ontario, Woodbine Entertainment CEO Jim Lawson attributes part of the Woodbine Mohawk success to technological investments made in recent years.

"In Canada, for starters, the last couple of years we became dependent on our ADW platform, HPIbet, which is a really clever, and technologically advanced system to use. People have turned to it during this pandemic as online wagering has become more prevalent, and the HPIbet platform has been great for us," Lawson said.

"That's the Canadian equation. Now as part of the U.S. equation where a lot of growth has been, we've gained a lot of momentum from having such a spectacular August and September. Through our marketing, racing and broadcast teams as well as quality of racing, there's no question that we've been growing our market share and brand in the U.S. and around the world."

Recent positive trends experienced by the industry comes at a time where there is presumed to be emerging competition for a finite set of wagering dollars. It's impressive that as online gaming and sportsbooks expand across the country, harness racing handle, at least to date, continues to hold its own.

This year may tell us if these pandemic years were an aberration or if the industry has something sustainable to work with.

Oh, Henry!

Henry Cano thought he was being punked when he was told he had been named the 2021 Fair Island Farm Caretaker of the Year.

When Sarah Svanstedt told Henry Cano he was named 2021 Fair Island Farm Caretaker of the Year, he thought it was a joke.

"I said, 'What are you talking about?'" said Cano. "She said, 'You

were nominated to be the Groom of the Year. I think you won.' I said, 'Are you serious, or are you just playing with me?' She said 'It's for real. You don't believe me?'"

It took a couple of days and a call from Ken Weingartner for reality to sink in for Cano.

Cano has worked for Åke and Sarah Svanstedt for three years and took care of six horses last year, including Captain Corey, Ambassador Hanover and Delayed Hanover, who finished first, third and fourth, respectively, in the 2021 Hambletonian. All three of those colts were in Cano's care from the day they arrived at the Svanstedt stable as yearlings.

Cano was nominated for the Caretaker award by the Svanstedts as well as 10 of his fellow caretakers.

"Never have I heard other workers saying a bad word about him, but that's because he has his two feet on the ground and he's just easy going," said Sarah. "And even with the success it hasn't changed him one bit.

"Thanks to everyone who voted for him, because without them, it wouldn't have been possible."

The winner is chosen by a seven-person committee comprised of members of the U.S. Harness Writers Association (USHWA), all former caretakers themselves.

"I believe it was the outpouring of support through nominations

from Henry's peers highlighting his work ethic and dedication to his horses that saw him garner the most votes from the committee," said committee chairman Tim Bojarski. "When you have the respect of your peers in any business or occupation or career, that speaks volumes, because those are the people that know the best.

"Everyone on the committee did agree that this is the most difficult award to select one individual for as every caretaker nominated is a credit to the industry and worthy of recognition."

A total of 18 caretakers were nominated for the award sponsored by Art Zubrod and Leah Cheverie's Fair Island Farm in conjunction with USHWA. All nominated caretakers will receive a certificate recognizing their accomplishments.

"We should all, as an organization, be thankful to have them as a sponsor," said Bojarski.

In addition to the recognition garnered by winning this award, Cano will receive a cash prize of \$1,000, transportation costs to the USHWA Dan Patch Awards banquet in Orlando, FL, a two-night stay at the host hotel (Rosen Shingle Creek), two tickets to the banquet and a trophy.

It's interesting to think that this magical season almost didn't happen for Cano, who was planning to move back home to his native Guatemala when fate intervened via a phone call from his friend Luis, who worked for the Svanstedts. Luis told Cano that they needed help and had a lot of stakes horses.

"What me and Åke see most in [Henry] is that he really cares for the horses," said Sarah. "Many people go to work for the work, but he goes for his horses every day. He's a really great caretaker. You can see that it's more than work for him that he cares daily what's going on with his horses. We have been blessed to have a good crew behind us and many have worked many years for us so that's a big help."

Sarah has never seen Cano stressed and thinks his horses can feel that. Even with three horses in the Hambletonian, he was calm.

"I said to Åke, 'He's not a single bit nervous,'" said Sarah. "He was

the same as if it was a qualifying day. He's like, it's just another race. He's the same seven days a week and it's just amazing to see that he can handle that. Having three for the Hambo I would be white in my face."

Cano likes all of his horses and would prefer not to choose a favorite, but if he had to, it would be Captain Corey.

"I liked his gait," said Cano. "He learned fast. He was just special from the first day we had him in the stable. It was pretty easy to work around him. He showed that he was a very talented horse and he liked to trot."

Cano has not been back to Guatemala to visit for a while, but stays in close contact with his family, who are proud of his accomplishments even if he's too humble to call and tell them about his most recent achievement.

"They don't know yet, but I think they're going to find out soon," said Cano. "In the Hambo, I didn't tell them anything but they found out. They said, 'I saw you in a picture.' And I said that wasn't me and they said 'Yes, it was you.'"

"I'm pretty happy about it and pretty excited to receive that award. I never thought I would be groom of the year. I was lucky to win the Hambo and groom of the year also."

Last chance to qualify for the Prix d’Amerique comes in Sunday’s Prix de Belgique

The \$135,000 Prix de Belgique is set for Sunday (Jan. 16) at Vincennes. As always, the race falls two weeks before the Jan. 30 Prix d’Amérique in Paris. That makes the Prix de Belgique the last chance for horses to qualify for the big race.

Fifteen trotters are in the race and the most merited, at least in terms of lifetime earnings, is Jean-Michel Bazire-trained Davidson du Pont, who practically has his spot in Prix d’Amérique already due to his high bank account.

Last Sunday (Jan.9), some big races were on the Vincennes’ race card and Bazire presented a Finnish bred 4-year-old in perfect condition in the \$135,000 Prix Charles-Tiercelin.

Dusktodawn Boogie (Lexus Font) finished strongly three wide during the race’s last half-mile and even though Bazire started the attack from fifth over, the filly had speed enough to disarm the front horses in the stretch. Leader Ideal Lignerles looked like he would claim the trophy in mid-stretch, but Dusktodawn Boogie put her nose first. The mile rate over 1.3 miles was 1:55.4.

Philippe Allaire’s 3-year-old **Just A Gigolo** won the \$135,000 Prix Maurice de Gheest in a stakes record of 2:00.4 over 1.6 miles and the son of Boccador de Simm claimed his sixth win in seven starts. Just A Gigolo came to the lead with a mile to go and driver Franck Nivard had everything under safe control on his way towards the wire.

Allaire dominates the big races for younger horses in France and Sunday marked his eighth career victory in the Prix Maurice de Gheest.

The biggest race on the Sunday card at Vincennes was the \$170,000 Prix du Calvados, for horses racing under saddle. Early leader Fadu du Chene had some 30 meters advantage to his opponents when the judges at Vincennes decided to disqualify the horse with a kilometer to go in the 1.6-mile-long race. The judges wasn’t happy with the way Fado du Chene gaited so jockey Paul Philippe Ploquin had to leave his position. Instead, **Fantaisie** (Un Mec d’Heripre) was the leader of the gang. And Fantaisie held all the way, even when Jerry Riordan-trained Zarenne Fas seriously challenged over the home stretch.

Seven-year-old Fantaisie came home in a mile rate of 1:57.1 and she is now ready for the Prix de Cornulier next weekend. The same goes for Zarenne Fas and bronze medalist Bilooka du Boscaill.





How a different nose would have changed history

What would have happened if some of the most famous victories in the sport's history had gone the other way?

Consider:

Bonefish over Yankee Bambino in the 1975 Hambletonian in the 4th and final heat. Neither trotter ever raced again. Bonefish, had he not won, would have given Stanley Dancer four career Hambletonian trophies as a trainer instead of five. For runner-up Walter Ross, it would have given him the honor of winning the richest race to that point in Hambletonian history (\$232,000). Just two years later, Ross won the richest ever 2-year-old race to that point, the first ever Woodrow Wilson with No No Yankee for \$280,000.

Beach Towel headed off Jake And Elwood by a nostril in the 1990 Meadowlands Pace. Had that been reversed, it would have given John Campbell eight career Pace trophies, and it would have meant that Dr. John Hayes, not Ray Remmen, would have been the last trainer/driver to capture the Meadowlands Pace (Hayes won it in 1981 with Conquered). It also would have meant that Precious Bunny in 1991, not Beach Towel, would have been the first single-season \$2 million winner.

McKinzie Almahurst over Lon Todd Hanover in the \$1,760,000 Woodrow Wilson of 1981. The fourth richest race ever saw Billy Haughton lasting on the lead over John Simpson, Jr. If reversed, Haughton would not be the only driver and trainer (in two separate events) to win a \$1.5 million plus event – having taken the \$2,161,000 Wilson of 1984 as a trainer with Nihilator. It also would have given sire Albatross his richest single race win. Remember, in 1979-1980-1981, he had the Horse of the Year all three years with Niatross twice and Fan Hanover.

Guy McKinney nosed out Guy Dean in the first ever Hambletonian in 1926. It wouldn't have mattered to stallion Guy Axworthy, he sired both of the top two. But Walter Cox would have been elevated over Nat Ray and would not have had to wait until 1929 to win it with Walter Dear. Would the Nat Ray Trot have

instead been the Wally Cox?

Jate Lobell nosed out Frugal Gourmet in the first million-dollar race in Canada, the 1987 North America Cup. Mark O'Mara with the 1986 Horse of the Year runner-up. Had the NA Cup gone the other way, then Frugal Gourmet would have been the first horse at age 3 to win two million-dollar events since he got revenge three weeks later in the Meadowlands Pace. Nihilator had won two races valued at over \$1 million at 2 and 3 (Wilson at 2; Pace at 3)

Marion Marauder over Southwind Frank in the 2016 Hambletonian. Marion Marauder was the last Triple Crown winner in the sport, winning three photos in three Triple Crown tests. If he had faltered in any of them, it would then be Glidemaster who would hold the distinction of having won the last Triple Crown (in 2006).

Arizona Jack over Stout in the 1996 NA Cup. This one would normally slip through the cracks, except had Arizona Jack not got up a nose for John Campbell and Gary Machiz, then Campbell would not be the only driver to win the same million-dollar race four consecutive times: Cams Card Shark (1994); Davids Pass (1995); Arizona Jack and Gothic Dream (1997).

Wiggle It Jiggle it by a nose over Lost For Words in the 2015 Little Brown Jug. Twenty-four-year-old Montrell Teague with the incredibly game HOY WIJ and Dave Miller with the Brian Brown trainee just missing in an epic duel. Had this been changed, Dave Miller would now have six Jugs and stand alone on the all-time list.

Scott Frost held off Galophone by a scant nose in 1955 in the Hambletonian. Joe O'Brien over Billy Haughton. Had that one gone the other way, it would have forced a duel between the two again in a summary. As it was, Scott Frost was 1-1 and Galophone 3-2. Hey, who knows if we would have had to wait for our first Triple Crown winner (Speedy Scot won next it in 1963 on the trot; Adios Butler in 1959 on the pace). Remember too that Billy Haughton would not – possibly – have had to wait another 19 years for his very first Hambletonian at age 50 in 1974 with Christopher T.

Carls Bird an eyelash over Trutone Lobell in the 1983 Woodrow Wilson for a purse of \$1,700,000, making it the fifth richest race ever held. Carl Allen over Cat Manzi. Had this been switched, it means Carl and Rod Allen would not be the only father-son million-dollar race winners (with Rod winning the 1992 Meadowlands Pace with Carlsbad Cam), it also means that the Catman would not have waited another generation – 21 years to be exact – to win his first million-dollar race (the 2004 NA Cup with Mantacular).

Jeff Gregory and Jonas Czernyson with Jalopy winning the 2005 Hambletonian Oaks over Blur. That was the first year that the fillies on Hambletonian day went for \$750,000. That remains the richest race won by both. Gregory later drove both Market Share and Chapter Seven.

The 2009 Hambletonian Oaks may have been the tightest photo ever on Hambletonian Day – and I am counting the 1989 Dead heat. How did they separate Broadway Schooner and Raising Rachel? The nod went to Broadway Schooner, a daughter of Broadway Hall who would later sire the 2011 Hambletonian winner Broad Bahn. Broadway Schooner and Muscle Hill's driver Brian Sears would not have been the first driver to ever win the Hambletonian/Oaks on the same day as the Hambletonian had that photo gone the other way.

Speaking of tight photos

Hoot Mon won the Hambletonian rather easily in 1947 by two lengths. But take a look at the margins of his four Hambletonian winners:

1953 Helicopter a HEAD 17-1-1 in summary

1955 Scott Frost a NOSE 1-1 in summary

1960 Blaze Hanover a NOSE over another Hoot Frost 1-7-3-1 in summary

1962 A Cs Viking a NOSE 1-1 in summary.

Cordarius “Cash Deposit” Stewart looking for steady growth in 2022

Cordarius Stewart and his dollar signs.

The man from Mississippi has come a long way, literally and figuratively, from his driving days in the Magnolia State.

Cordarius Stewart was just a teenager when he sat in the stand-ardbred bike for his first race, a dash at one of the many county fairs that dot the Mississippi landscape.

His first two starts, at age 13, yielded a pair of second-place finishes, both narrow misses, mere inches keeping him from two trips to the winner's circle.

The third time, however, would be the charm for the polite-spoken kid from Jackson, the Mississippi capital and most populous city in the southern state.

Although the career highlight came some 14 years ago, Stewart's recollection of the victory is as crystal clear as the photo that was taken to capture the treasured moment.

“I got nosed out twice in my first two drives. So, I had two seconds. But I can easily remember the day I got my first win, which was a week later, with one of my own mares. Her name was Riley Richess. I have to say I was nervous because there were a lot of people watching. But once I got on the track and we went to the gate, all those nerves went away. We won on the front end. It was easy. They let me walk to the half in 1:05 and I sprinted home in a minute. I loved it. I can say it was a good feeling.”

The win also reminded him of what it took to make it a reality.

“I learned responsibility early on in my life. My dad, who was in the business, he let me train all the horses myself. When it was race time, he gave me a chance to drive when he would normally put other people down to drive. He knew I was young, but he knew I would work hard, that I would listen and that I would learn. When the day finally came for me to drive in a race, I was ready.”

Fast forward six years, and the horseman found himself in Illinois – Crete, to be precise – where he tested the waters of Balmoral Park.

Just 19 at the time, Stewart was eager to make inroads in his fledgling career, seeking to get that first pari-mutuel win under his belt, and with it, the chance to draw more attention from local trainers and owners.

He didn't have to wait long to make an impression.

On the night of Nov. 24, 2013, Stewart partnered his very own Chili Beach, a pacing son of Sportsmaster—Talkofthebeach, in a \$4,500 maiden race.

Sent on their way on a brutally cold night when the mercury dipped to a bone-chilling 5 Fahrenheit, the duo dead-heated for first in 1:56.3.

"It was really, really cold. I had a good trip, and it ended up getting us the win. That was a great feeling, too. I had thought about achieving that for a long time, so for it to come true, it was really satisfying."

While the win didn't pay immediate dividends, business-wise, Stewart remained patient and determined, dedicated to his craft and unwavering in his belief that better days were indeed ahead.

After a five-win campaign in 2018, Stewart finally had his break-out campaign three years ago.

An 88-win season in 2019 was followed by 52 victories in 2020.

It was a venture south to the sunny climes of California, to drive at Cal-Expo's one-mile oval in Sacramento, that proved to be a winning move for Stewart.

"I think I've been patient and I never got down on myself at any point. Coming to California has been good for me. It's another opportunity to drive for different people, to get better at what I do, and to use that confidence to get the results you want."

When Cal-Expo's current meet wraps up on May 1, Stewart will trek back to the Midwest, namely, Hawthorne, to resume his association with the Illinois racing scene.

He'll also head to Running Aces, the five-eighths mile track in Columbus, MN, to test his luck there.

More experiences, Stewart offered, creates more opportunities to hone his skills on different stages.

"I think each place gives you a unique view of racing. Everything is really different everywhere you go, but that's a good thing to have. I also have a horse I own, Opulent (a bay daughter of Bettors Delight) that I'm hoping can have a good year too."

As for what he perceives to be his best quality in the race bike, Stewart ruminates briefly before offering up a response.

"I think I'm really good coming off the pace and bringing them home. I can get them home pretty good. I like that feeling of flying home, working as hard as you can to get the horse to the wire first. Whether it's a favorite or a longshot, when you are rolling down the lane it's an amazing rush."

Just like he experienced at Cal-Expo in 2021.

Stewart teamed with Frewil Dakota Sven, a pacing son of Up Front Brad co-owned by trainer Richard Bertrand, to rhyme off back-to-back scores in April.

"We pulled off an upset on the best horse (Allmyxsliventexas) on the grounds and beat him two straight weeks. That was a really nice feeling and I was lucky to get to drive such a nice horse. Hopefully, I get a chance to drive some more good ones too."

There's no doubt Stewart, who will turn 28 in April, looks the part on the racetrack.

When he returned to racing in 2017, he needed some new racing colors.

"This guy was selling colors and I bought ones that were worn by Jordan Stratton. I started using those and they gave me good luck my first year. I ended up using them at Hawthorne and everyone started calling me Jordan. I changed my colors and put dollar signs on them instead of 'S.' I got the idea from [driver] Brandon Bates. My nickname is CD. Brandon said one day, 'You should put some dollar signs on your suit. Your initials are CD, so we'll call you Cash Deposit.' I liked it. And now people call me that. Everybody has the stars and horseshoes, but Brandon suggested I put dollar signs on mine, so I did. It's different and I like it."

Stewart will look to cash in on his unique look in 2022 and well beyond, wherever he happens to be holding the reins.

"I want to get my average and numbers up this year. That's my goal. Looking back, I fell in love with the sport right away from those early days in Mississippi and I still do now. There's still a lot what I want to achieve, and I know I'm ready for whatever challenge comes next."

Tharps hopes to create more Big M memories in this weekend's Martin Luther King Jr. event

Every morning when he wakes up, Devon Tharps is reminded of one of the best nights of his life. It occurred Jan. 16, 2021, when Tharps drove Acting Out to victory in the Martin Luther King Jr. Remembrance Race at The Meadowlands.

To win such a meaningful event would be enough to make it memorable, but there was another reason it was momentous for Tharps. It was the first triumph of his career, and it proved to be a steppingstone for the 28-year-old driver to increase his workload. Tharps, who works for trainer Tony Alagna's stable, got 96 more drives the rest of the year and posted an additional 12 victories.

This weekend, Tharps will return to The Meadowlands for an expanded slate of MLK events, which honor the memory of slain civil rights leader King, who was born Jan. 15, 1929.

Tonight (Jan. 14), there will be a GSY Amateur Series/MLK Remembrance Race followed later in the card by the Martin Luther King Jr. Remembrance Race featuring 10 African-American drivers. On Saturday (Jan. 15), there is another Martin Luther King Jr. Remembrance Race as well as Pro-MLK Remembrance Race.

This is the fifth consecutive year The Meadowlands is playing host to the tribute to King. Tharps is driving in all but the GSY event and will hope to repeat his success of a year ago.

"That is a night I'll never forget," Tharps said. "I've got the trophy and the picture hanging up in my room. I wake up every morning and look at it. First win in an event like that, that was awesome."

It really meant a lot to me just to participate and represent such a staple in our country, especially with everything going on in the world right now. It was very special.

"It was definitely one of the best nights of my life, for sure. It was huge."

One other reason the night was memorable, Tharps drove against his cousin Eric Tharps Jr. for the first time. Eric finished third.

"I remember back in the day we used to hook race bikes up to the fence and drive against each other like that," Tharps said with a laugh. "So, it was definitely cool driving against each other that night. And it was cool beating him."

Following that night, Tharps put his driving on hold until the summer. In mid-July, he began getting in the sulky on a regular basis at Lexington's Red Mile, where he won 10 of 77 starts and participated in several state-bred stakes races.

"When I went to Kentucky, a lot of people would put me up because of that (MLK) race," Tharps said. "With the Meadowlands being one of the biggest stages, a lot of people watched that race. It kind of blew up over social media that night, too, so it definitely was an eye-opener for people."

"That has helped my driving career a lot and Tony has taught me a lot. It's really helped get my name out there working for him. Tony and a couple owners, like Myron Bell, they believe in me and give me chances and opportunities. They're good people. Tony has got good owners. Lexington was a good meet for me."

Tharps hopes to continue on the path to becoming a catch driver in the future.

"That's the plan," Tharps said. "Working for Tony brings a lot of opportunity my way and I really enjoy working for him, but eventually I'd like to see my career take off."

In last year's MLK race, Tharps and the Symon Spicer-trained pacer Acting Out rallied from mid-pack at three-quarters to win by 1-3/4 lengths over Randy Crisler-driven Pogey Beach. Tonight, Tharps will drive Rockin Panda for Spicer and is 9-2 on the morning line. On Saturday, Tharps will be behind Captain Hill (8-1) for Dan Morrissey and Claytons Bettor N (3-1 favorite) for Bill MacKenzie.

"I had some success over the summer, and I think I'm definitely a better driver going into it," Tharps said. "Hopefully, we can make it happen again."

The Meadowlands will present 15-race cards both tonight and Saturday. On Saturday, the top purse events are the \$31,500 preferred trot, where Chin Chin Hall is the 5-2 favorite, and the \$31,500 preferred pace, with Let It Ride N getting the nod, also at 5-2.

Millionaire Hypnotic AM is retired

Female trotter Hypnotic AM, who won the 2019 Jim Doherty Memorial and earned \$1.45 million lifetime, has been retired and will be bred to star French stallion Ready Cash, trainer Marcus Melander said. The 5-year-old, owned by Courant Inc., was expected last week in France, where Ready Cash stands at Haras de Bouttemont.

For her career, Hypnotic AM won 13 of 37 races and finished among the top three a total of 28 times. In addition to winning the Doherty, she captured New York Sire Stakes championships at ages 2 and 3 and a Kentucky Sire Stakes final at 3.

She had second-place finishes in the 2020 Hambletonian Oaks, Kentucky Filly Futurity, and Harry M. Zweig Memorial for 3-year-old fillies as well as in the 2021 Hambletonian Maturity and Graduate Series final. She was third in the Breeders Crown at age 2.

Overall, she earned a paycheck in all but two starts, and was no worse than fourth in 23 of 24 career races on the Grand Circuit.

"She had a fabulous career," Melander said. "She raced against the best ones from (ages) 2 to 4 and she never really threw in a bad race."

Hypnotic AM's best win time, 1:50.3, came in a preliminary leg of the Graduate Series at The Meadowlands last June as she defeated six male rivals including eventual Hambletonian Maturity champion Beads and returning Dan Patch Award-recipient Amigo

Volo.

"She had it all," Melander said. "She could go around the small tracks, the big tracks; her gait was phenomenal. She raced early on those half-mile tracks in New York, and she went around those turns like she'd never done anything else. She also had the strength; she won the Jim Doherty first over. She was just a very, very nice horse."

Hypnotic AM, bred by Courant A B, is a daughter of Chapter Seven out of Daydream AM S.

"I think Ready Cash will fit her very good," Melander said. "It will be very interesting to see her offspring in the future."

Breeders Crown returns to Woodbine Mohawk Park in 2022

The \$6.7 million (USD) Breeders Crown, harness racing's richest and most prestigious year-end divisional championship series, returns in the last weekend of October, 2022 to Woodbine Mohawk Park in Campbellville, ON.

All Breeders Crown divisions are now guaranteed at \$600,000, with the exception of the Open Mare Pace and Trot which have been raised to a minimum of \$350,000.

Eliminations, if necessary, for freshman races will be held Friday, Oct. 21, with 3-year-old and older eliminations raced Saturday, Oct. 22. Finals for 2-year-olds get underway the next Friday, Oct. 28 with sophomore finals and open events following on Saturday, Oct. 29.

Woodbine Entertainment last played host to all 12 events in 2019, smashing handle and attendance records at the seven-eighths mile track, with \$11.1 million wagered over the four fall nights. The 2019 events were capped by a sensational victory in the Crown Trot by French star Bold Eagle, who retired with earnings of \$5,878,322.

The 2019 Breeders Crown at Woodbine Mohawk Park also initiated the successful and subsequent three-year sponsorship of the Libfeld-Katz Breeding Partnership, which was also responsible for creating and executing the Breeders Crown Charity Challenge. The Breeders Crown Charity Challenge, brainchild of breeder/owner Marvin Katz, has since raised over \$800,000 in three years, supporting numerous local charities in Crown host track communities.

Woodbine Entertainment has played host to more Breeders Crown events than any other venue at their tracks of Woodbine, Mohawk and Greenwood, for a total of 152.

"The Woodbine name is recognized as one of harness racing's leading brands and we are excited and proud to partner with them and bring the Breeders Crown series back to Canada," said John Campbell, president and CEO of the Hambletonian Society, which owns and administers the races.

"Woodbine is thrilled to welcome back the Breeders Crown to Woodbine Mohawk Park this October," said Jim Lawson, CEO of Woodbine Entertainment. "Hosting the Breeders Crown continues our commitment to a world-class racing product, and we're focused on once again producing an exceptional two-night event showcasing the very best in our sport."

The Breeders Crown series has typically crowned champions in every division for trotters and pacers and been the deciding factor in Horse of the Year honors. A Breeders Crown title is one of the most coveted honors in harness racing.

Merriman and Schillaci capture 2021 MGM Northfield Park dash titles

Aaron Merriman again topped the MGM Northfield Park driving ranks in 2021, winning 548 races over the Flying Turns. His nearest competitor, Ronnie Wrenn Jr., drove 399 winners. Kurt Sugg (326), Chris Lems (250) and Hunter Myers (245) completed the top five reinsmen.

Merriman, 43, resides in Northfield, OH and now has 10 driving titles under his belt. He won the dash titles at Northfield Park in 2006-2009, 2012, and 2017-2021. Merriman has won more races at MGM Northfield Park than any driver in the track's 65-year history. He is also the youngest person ever inducted into the Northfield Park Wall of Fame.

Merriman's 2021 total victory tally was 860, which again ranked him as the winningest driver in North America. Tim Tetrick was the runner-up with 658 wins. Ronnie Wrenn Jr. (611), Trace Tetrick (559) and George Napolitano Jr. (508) complete the top-5 North American drivers. 2021 marks the seventh consecutive North American Dash Title won by Aaron Merriman.

Merriman began driving in 1997 and has since won over 13,500 races and purses approaching \$95 million. Merriman's fastest win ever was aboard Kanaris at Scioto Downs in 1:48.3 in 2014. The richest purse he has ever won is \$300,000, which he has done multiple times in both Ohio and Kentucky Sire Stake Finals.

MGM Northfield Park's 2021 leading trainer Sam Schillaci won 22 more races than any other local conditioner. He garnered 170 victories throughout last year. Bill Rhoades finished second with 148 wins. Brian Loney (132), Edward Miller (104) and Ron Burke (93) rounded out the top five Northfield Park trainers for 2021.

Schillaci, originally from Warsaw, NY, now lives in Macedonia, OH with his wife Jodi and their three dogs.

Schillaci, 59, scored his first training win in 1991 at Buffalo Raceway. Sam has nearly 1,400 career training victories with purse earnings approaching \$12 million. The 2021 Northfield

title is the second local dash victory for Sam. He has also took the Northfield training honors in 2018.

Merriman and Schillaci will be honored with an official presentation in the Winner's Circle later this month.

Gingras and Ford off to quick 2022 starts at Meadowlands

Two horsemen stood out in front of the rest during the first weekend of racing at The Meadowlands in 2022 as driver Yannick Gingras recorded eight winners over the course of Jan. 7-8 while trainer Mark Ford schooled four to victory lane.

Gingras, who will be inducted into harness racing's Hall of Fame in July, was the bettors' best friend, winning at a 32 per cent clip. His three seconds and five thirds gave him a total of 16 on-the-board finishes from 25 starts, meaning that the 42-year-old Quebec native "hit the ticket" 64 per cent of the time.

His Return On Investment (ROI) was plus 18 per cent.

Heading into Friday's card, Gingras thought he might have some success. He was right, hitting victory lane five times.

"I had some power and they were ready to race," said Gingras.

And what's ahead for this season?

"I'm looking forward to staying healthy and having a good 2022," said Gingras. "Atlanta is coming back. And Branded By Lindy. There's many others I'm looking forward to driving. This Is The Plan. And Blue Diamond Eyes, who finished [2021] strong."

Ford's four scores came from just five starts, and his lone non-winner came in third, so his win (80) and in-the-money (100) percentages were both remarkable.

His ROI was off the charts at plus 426 per cent, as his winners returned \$6.60, \$17.20, \$16.80 and \$12.20 to win. Gingras drove all but one of Ford's winner's circle visitors.

"Every little bit helps. It's not the first time that's happened, you know," joked Ford, with his tongue firmly in cheek.

On a more serious note, the president of the Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey for the last seven years is pleased with the current harness racing environment in the Garden State.

"There have been a lot of ups and downs over the last four or five years," said Ford. "We have finally righted the ship and it seems like better times are ahead. Getting a piece of the sports wagering and the appropriation from the state have us going well now."

"[Meadowlands chairman and chief executive officer] Jeff Gural, some people like him, some don't, but the proof is in the pudding. He has gone after the drug problem and bettors have a

good feeling that they are getting a better shake when they go to The Meadowlands."

Dr. Mossbarger, who lives in Bloomingburg, OH with his wife Kyle is the president of Midland Acres, a family-owned breeding farm. He joined the OHHA Board of Directors in 1984 and served as the Association's president for six years, from 1998-2003.

As a past president, Mossbarger serves on the Advisory Committee for the OHHA and is the Association's legislative Political Action Committee Chairman. In addition, he is a member of the United States Trotting Association Board of Directors serving for District 1.

A graduate of the Ohio State School of Veterinary Medicine, Dr. Mossbarger serves on a variety of boards including the Hambletonian Society, Inc., Ohio Farm Bureau, Fayette County Farm Bureau, and the National Federation of Independent Businesses. He is also a past president of the Ohio Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association.

Dr. Mossbarger is being recognized for his professional contributions to Ohio's Standardbred breeding program as well as his involvement with the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation and United States Trotting Association.

The Maynard and Stella Hagemeyer Significant Contribution Award is awarded to an individual that has made a significant life-long contribution to Ohio harness racing. The individual must possess a passion and advocacy for Ohio harness racing. The award is based on the importance of educating and involving local and state legislators to the importance of the harness racing industry.

As well, **Dr. Dan Wilson** and **Tom Laughbaum** will be presented the 2021 Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association Special Service to Harness Racing Awards at the OHHA banquet.

Dr. Wilson was raised on a farm in Sabina, OH and graduated from The Ohio State University School of Veterinary Medicine in 1975. He joined the Randall Veterinary Clinic near Cleveland and began practicing on the backstretch of Northfield Park.

He spent nearly 50 years making significant, life-long contributions to Ohio harness racing before retiring in the spring of 2021.

Dr. Wilson was once quoted as saying, “Growing up, I couldn't get enough of horses. It's a great satisfaction to be able to improve their life, make them feel better and make them healthier. I'm a racetrack practitioner, and the rewarding part to me is to see what you've done and accomplished. It's just wonderful to see them go out and do what they're supposed to do.”

Laughbaum has been a member of Crawford County Fair Board for four decades and has served as the Speed Superintendent for over 25 years.

During his time on the fair board, Laughbaum has spearheaded projects big and small to improve local harness racing in whatever way possible. He gathers sponsors for every race, prepares race programs and payouts, oversees draws, and is the official timer on race days. He has played a major role in advancing Bucyrus harness racing with track and barn improvements as well as helping host the annual spring matinee.

Meanwhile, **Winning Ticket** has been named 2021 Ohio 3-Year-Old Trotting Colt of the Year

Winning Ticket rolled off 10 straight wins to start the season on his way to being named the 2021 Ohio 3-Year Trotting Colt of the Year.

The son of Triumphant Caviar won 11 of 12 races earning \$422,213 for the ownership group of trainer Chris Beaver, Steven Zeelandar, Tim Homan, and Jim Burnett.

Bred by James Bender, Winning Ticket won the Ohio State Fair Stakes and the \$300,000 Ohio Sire Stakes before finishing third in the Canadian Trotting Classic. He wrapped up the season winning the Ohio Breeders Championship to claim the Ohio Triple Crown.

In 20 career starts, Winning Ticket has hit the wire first in 15 races, earning \$517,260.

Beaver says Winning Ticket is the best Triumphant Caviar he has ever trained. “He was dominant this year. My goal was just to keep him healthy to the final.”

Winning Ticket stayed healthy until he was injured in winning the Ohio Breeders Championship. Beaver says he tore a suspensory but says the prognosis is good. “It is not as bad as it could be. I have some experience with injuries like this and we are hoping to bring him back next year.”

Finally, **Herculisa** has been named Ohio 3-Year-Old Trotting Filly of the Year.

From the end of June until the beginning of October, Herculisa flexed her muscles, winning seven times in eight starts.

Herculisa claimed the Ohio Triple Crown by winning the Ohio Fair Stakes, the Ohio Sire Stakes Finals, and the Ohio Breeders Championship. She set a world record in the Sires Stakes Final becoming the fastest 3-year-old filly on a half-mile track.

The daughter of My MVP is trained by Virgil Morgan Jr. and owned by Jesmeral Stables. Morgan said she matured as a three-year-old and showed her versatility. "She has an enormous amount of talent. She set the world record at Northfield cutting the mile and doing all the work and she won at Lexington after making a power move."

Bred by Joe McLead, Billy Walters, and Up Front Racing, Herculisa won seven of 14 starts, earning \$410,833 in 2021.

Herculisa, Winning Ticket, Dr. John Mossbarger, Dr. Dan Wilson and Tom Laughbaum will all be honored at the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association Annual Awards Banquet Saturday (Jan. 15) at the Hilton Columbus-Polaris in Columbus, OH.

The 2021 Ohio Horse of the Year will be announced at the banquet.

Virginia's new standardbred Sired Stakes program off to rousing start

The Virginia Harness Horse Association (VHHA), which introduced a new Sired Stakes program in mid-November, announced that the number of stallions standing in the state has risen from five, in 2021, to 12 this year as a direct result of the initiative.

The program, which starts with the 2022 breeding season for foals of 2023, will offer bonus payments for foals that meet qualifying times and dates as outlined in the rules at vhha.net. Both the stallion owner and breeder will receive \$1,500, and if the mare and foal remain in Virginia for the entire foaling year, the mare owner will receive an additional \$1,500.

Sired Stake races will be run based on age, sex and gait as 2- and 3-year-olds. Elimination races will feature a \$6,000 purse and finals will go for \$60,000. Sired foals are also eligible to compete in the Breeder's Fund races during the same years, which feature \$8,000 elims and \$80,000 finals.

Four of the previous stallions remain active. Artzina, a pacer, stands in Pilgrim Knob, farthest southwest point in the state. He bankrolled \$780,063 over his career from lucrative two-year-old wins in the Matron Stakes and New Jersey Sire Stakes. Trotter Gregory Pecs, a sire of 21 foals that have placed in Virginia Breeder's Fund races, stands at the Schlabach Farm in Tazewell.

The other returnees, trotters Snow King and Secular, will be based in Nathalie at the farms of David Troyer and Cristy Yoder respectively. Another trotting stallion, Glendening, will stand at the Stoltzfus Farm in nearby Charlotte Courthouse.

A trio of stallions are based at Snow Hill Farm in Troy, located in Central Virginia. Trotter Shibboleth Hanover, who moved from Florida to stand in Virginia, has sired four Florida Breeder's stakes winners and four Florida Stallion Stakes winners. Trotter Kandy Korn is a past winner of the Maryland Standardbred Fund as both a 2- and 3-year-old. Pacer Journeyman had 34 career wins, bankrolled \$425,000 and took a mark of 1:50.0.

The Double C/C Bar Ranch in Keysville will host two stallions – trotter Yankee Royalty and pacer Strong Player. The former moved from Delaware to stand in Virginia while the latter relocated from Ohio.

The final two stallions will stand at farms in opposite directions. Trotter Winning Fireworks is a proven sire of 47 starters with earnings of \$1,290,516 while pacer Mr. Julian amassed \$318,607 in his career and has a life mark of 1:48 4/5. They will stand at Willow Hill Equestrian in Orange and at the Black Diamond Farms in Hurley.

Harness Racing Museum & Hall of Fame awarded art conservation funding

The Harness Racing Museum & Hall of Fame announced this week that it has received \$4,839 in grant funding from the Greater Hudson Heritage Network (GHHN) for the conservation treatment of two 19th century paintings. Both paintings, Trotting Horse Driver with Mountains (1884) by William G. Van Zandt and trotting mare Aubine (1889) by Charles B. Fish, showcase the talent of New York-based artists and each is reflective of the cultural and historical importance of trotting horses to New York State history.

"These two paintings are significant works of art," said Harness Racing Museum director Janet Terhune, "and we are grateful for the financial assistance to conserve and preserve them for future generations. We know just where they will be exhibited in the Museum once conservation work is completed. I thank the GHHN grant committee for their generous support."

William G. Van Zandt's painting, Trotting Horse and Driver with Mountains (1884), provides a view of a tranquil New York landscape, juxtaposed to a horse in motion drawing the sporting carriage of a gentleman driver. A native of Albany, NY, Van Zandt's folk art style paintings, like this one, captured the vistas, occupants and activities of the Capital Region in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. While Van Zandt's work, likely created for the gentleman depicted, celebrates both horse and driver, the second painting to be conserved, Aubine (1889), by New York City-based artist Charles B. Fish, is focused solely on the conformation and beauty of the mare portrayed. Bred in Waterville, Maine, Aubine was a star of the racetrack before becoming the property of Lewis G. Tewksbury, one of Wall Street's most notorious boom and bust brokers. His purchase of the mare in 1894 appears to have been part of his effort to join New York City's society of wealthy and fashionable horsemen. A banker by trade, C.B. Fish (1853-1906) skirted the edges of this same division of New York high society, while also exploring his artistic avocation.

Funding for the conservation treatment of these two paintings was awarded to the Harness Racing Museum & Hall of Fame through the Conservation Treatment Grant Program administered by the Greater Hudson Heritage Network, a re-grant agency. This competitive annual grant initiative provides

support for treatment procedures by professional conservators to aid in stabilizing and preserving objects in collections of museums, historical, and cultural organizations in New York State. This program is made possible with public funds from the New York State Council on the Arts (NYSCA), with the support of the Office of the Governor and the New York State Legislature. The Robert David Lion Gardiner Foundation has provided additional dedicated support for conservation treatment projects on Long Island. This year's grant awards totaled \$138,157 to 25 organizations across New York State.
