

I ran into Marvin and his wife and friends again Tuesday night and reiterated that I meant nothing personal. However, I explained that there was definitely an ongoing conspiracy theory as proven by some of the ridiculous emails I have received on the subject.

I have been attacked lately on Facebook. If you have a problem with my writing, email HRU or myself. Please don't post it on social media. There is a distinct lack of intellect on Facebook, thus you give a platform for some dolts to go on the offensive with nothing to offer but idle banter. The average HRU subscriber is in a different IQ range and less likely to get involved in a nonsense thread.

Michael Donato asks: Marcus Melander had an amazing year and was named Trainer of the Year. Realizing how young he is, do you think it is a fluke or can he keep it going?

It's no fluke. "Baby Trainer" has great owners, trains on a fabulous surface and has numbers. Can he duplicate this year? It will be difficult, but not impossible. Although I love the surface of his track (the Stanley Dancer Farm in New Egypt, NJ) I question training big horses on that half mile. I trained on it for a few years and was successful with two little horses, Delicious and Lucy's Pearl, but had a big one that was compromised by the turns. To me, training 100 horses over it may prove a test for the young man. I have seen his operation and he is a hard worker and dedicated to his stock. After elimination of obstacles (i.e. the half mile), he can only get better.

I have pointed out in the past he has made mistakes, but he is very smart and will learn from these errors in judgment and be better year after year.


It is interesting to note that he was named Trainer of the Year exactly two decades after yours truly. When you look at the numbers, it is quite a major difference. About the only similarity was that we both had two good horses in the Hambletonian. After that, it was all better for Marcus.

In 1999, I was first and fourth with Self Possessed and Raphaello

Ambrosio in the Hambletonian and third in the Oaks with Bit O Candy. Self Possessed was second, in a controversial finish to the World Trotting Derby and won the Kentucky Futurity. Bit O Candy won the filly World Trotting Derby and they both won their divisions of the American National. Cherished Victory had a very good 2-year-old campaign, but that was it for me in 1999. My summary was 170 starts 39 wins \$2,064,639.

My numbers are embarrassing in comparison. Marcus trained Greenshoe, Gimpanzee, Green Manalishi S, plus the top 2-year-olds Hypnotic AM, Capricornus, Back Of The Neck, and Rome Pays Off. His amazing summary was 332 starts 86 wins and \$5,361,856. Maybe I should give my award back.

For sure the name Marcus Melander will be around for a very long time. Note: he had his first Hambletonian horse in his 20s. I



had mine in my mid 50s.

Arnold Beyer asks: What do you think about having consignors of yearlings having X-rays and scoping photos available at the sales?

I think you picked the wrong person to ask that question. I am sure there are some that would love the idea. I on the other hand am a total anti-veterinarian, when it comes to purchasing horses. I was partners with the famed New Bolton Center surgeon Dr Michael Ross on dozens of horses, most of which made good money, and after looking at each purchase (after the fact, I would never let him look before) he would say "Ronnie, how the hell did you ever buy him?"

I believe that vets are way too fussy. I realize it's their job, but not for my money. There is an instinct to buying horses and you must believe in yourself. If you love a horse and he has deformities you can live with, buy him. Talent and pedigree can conquer all.

Your timing asking this question comes almost the same week that an article was published in the *Thoroughbred Daily News* withan interview of Mark Taylor of Taylor Made in Kentucky where he feels the industry needs to re-examine the role x-rays and the repository play in the sales process. He said "From my perspective as someone who sells more yearlings than anyone else on the planet other than Keeneland and Fasig Tipton, we watch what these horses do" (Speaking of the ones that fall through the cracks because of poor x-rays).

"The correlation between the x-ray report and the way they run is very unpredictable."

He feels that ending the repository system for certain books at certain sales would be of great help to the small breeder.

We are not faced with many books at many sales and I find it hard to fathom how they can say where the rule begins i.e.: hip number 500 no more x-rays, but that is their problem. His idea makes me believe that I am on the same page and that is of no value overall.

Horsemen should get over some of the ridiculous fallacies in looking at a yearling before worrying about x-rays. Don't worry about toeing in or out, a video will tell you 90 per cent of the time if a colt is going to go to his knees. Don't do the four finger test, it is meaningless. Continental victory was three with a squeeze, but five when she was three as colts jaws keeps growing.

When you pick a good one, remember the silhouette and when you pick a bad one don't forget the silhouette.

Tom Santoro asks: Do you think the Meadowlands could conduct a special August meet leading up to the Hambletonian like they do in Saratoga, Keeneland and Del Mar? Could they invite the best drivers? How about some cameo appearances of Lachance, Campbell and Magee?

Tom, they do have a special meet, except it is in July. From the beginning of July to the first week in August ending with the Hambletonian they have the following stakes: the Kindergarten, NJSS, Meadowlands Pace, Graduate P&T, Mistletoe Shalee, Golden Girls, WR Haughton, Stanley Dancer, Delvin Miller, Hambletonian Maturity, Shady Daisy, Lady Liberty, Sam McKee, Peter Haughton, Jim Doherty, Merrie Anabelle, Hambletonian Oaks, Hambletonian, John Cashman, John Steele, Cane Pace and more.

There is no need to invite the best drivers because they are there to begin with. As for Mike, John and Dave, I would think they are

happy in retirement. You can't come off the bench in this sport after years of retirement and be competitive at the highest level. Add to that, driving horses is dangerous and in your 60s and 70s your reaction time is severely altered. Let those great men enjoy their retirement in peace.

Ramon Degennaro asks: How do racing authorities determine beaten lengths?

With a constantly running camera. At the finish line there is a photo finish camera that takes a constant photo of every horse that crosses the line. If you watch the races on television from any track when two horses are close at the wire they show a photo for win, place or show, whichever the case may be. Every horse has a finishing time that can determine beaten lengths. For example, they cannot chart beaten lengths or finish when the winner crosses the line because the order following can change before the race is over. There could be interference, a horse could fall, that is why every horse must go under the wire to be charted, otherwise Did Not Finish.





Five-year-old trotting mare Southwind Tesla (Chapter Seven-Southwind Sauna, \$204,957) topped the 2019 Mixed Sale with a bid of \$152,000 by agent Mario Zuanetti of Atlantic Trot Inc. of Pompano Beach, FL on behalf of Hickory Lane Farm of Ohio.

Formerly called the Tattersalls January Mixed Sale, last year saw 150 head / stallion shares gross \$4,395,300, for an average of \$29,302, that was off 3.3 per cent from the 2018 auction that topped the \$30,000 average for the first time in many years.

In 2018,221 horses/stallion shares grossed \$6,694,000 for an average of \$30,290.

In 2017,233 horses/stallion shares grossed \$6,288,400.


In 2016, 258 horses/stallion shares grossed \$5,849,400 for an average of \$22,672.

In 2015, 269 horses/stallion shares and breedings grossed \$5,971,500, for an average of \$23,291.

In 2014, the gross of \$5,971,500 for 234 horses/stallion shares produced an average of \$25,519.

In 2013, 206 horses and stallion shares grossed \$4,549,600, an average of \$22,085.

Emilia Leo - The girl on fire

Swedish driver and jockey Emilia Leo visited the winner's circle 118 times in 2019, a remarkable total in Europe where the 27-year-old superstar is gaining much-deserved attention across the business.

"You have your hopes and dreams about reaching this level some day and after the 2018 season, everything happened so fast," said Leo, who got her breakthrough as driver during the summer of 2018.

It was that year she presented trotters, trained by herself, in perfect shape in the V75, the best spotlight to use if an active horseperson wants to market themselves to a broader audience. Leo won 84 races in 2018 in 546 attempts while driving as an apprentice.


After New Year's Day 2020, Leo changed her status to amateur, which, in her case, means that she can continue to drive other trainer's horses, even in bigger staked races.

The year 2019 was sensational for Leo. More and more she was entrusted behind horses for some of the bigger trainers in Sweden and during the weekend of Elitloppet, she had a drive in one of the most prestigious races at Solvalla, the \$125,000 Sweden Cup.

Emilia Leo is a dual-threat as a driver and trotting under saddle jockey.

"I still try to think about how fun it is to drive races and I honestly don't feel any pressure when I enter the tracks. In a situation where I just drive for other trainers, I would maybe have felt differently but as it is for now, I have my own horses that I work with and I get my steady income by that. So the driving part is just a bonus, it is the fun part of the job and I love it. The fact that I can release some of the pressure in competition makes me a better driver," said Leo.

Winning 118 races — half of them came in racing under saddle events — is an impressive outcome for any driver in Sweden and Leo is not fond of the gender discussion in the harness racing business.

"I made a statement a few years ago where I criticized the difference between a 'bad' drive by me compared to a young, male driver who made exactly the same mistake in a race. It was so much easier to blame the bad result on me, a girl, when a young and over excited guy was just considered as eager and hungry. For me, there's no difference by gender in this sport. Everyone has the same opportunity to be successful, but historically it's been harder for female drivers to really go all the way to the top. What happened to me was that success opened doors. When I started to win, more trainers wanted my services and that in turn opened bigger

doors, for bigger races...and so on."

Leo's 701 starts in 2019 resulted in earnings of \$962,877. Among nearly 120 victories, she has one favorite that stands out. In September, she drove Shocking Superman for trainer Oscar Berglund in the \$42,150 Silverörnen, a gold division race in V75 on a Saturday, and it became a superior victory in a mile rate of 1:53.4 over 1.3 miles.

"But it's really hard to pick out different victories from a specific year. Every time I sit behind a horse, it means something different due to who you're driving for. I can feel the same satisfaction in a race where the purse is \$2,000 if I know that the people around the horse are happy with my job. The best thing for me last year was the fact that I got the chance to drive and ride horses throughout the whole season, some the same horses that the trainers wanted me to drive, and these collaborations means a lot to me today", she said.

For the moment, Leo is not contracted by any of the biggest stables in Sweden.

"And I don't know if I miss that part so much. I have great contact with the trainers I drive for and many of the best amateurs want me to drive for them and that's the best thing I know."

It's hard to avoid the girl-boy-subject when Emilia Leo is on the line. Even if she has her definite opinion that it is no different to be a woman in the game in 2020, she has noticed she has been a part of the switching of trends for female drivers in Sweden.

"There are some female drivers that have come to me where they've told me their stories, about how the business now is more open to let them get drives in races besides the ones for ladies or amateurs, so I hope that I, together with other women, have been an icebreaker for the sport," said Leo.

The success for the woman from Dalarna in Sweden continues in 2020 and she has already shown her abilities in the bike in the V75, where she won a race as late as on Jan. 10 at Bergsåker racetrack.

Even Vincennes in Paris has seen a glimpse of her during this winter meeting. In 1995, Swedish female driver Helen A Johansson made history by winning the Grand Prix d'Amérique paired with super mare Ina Scot. It was a feat hard to describe then, but when Emilia Leo enters the tracks 25 years later, there is hope that more women can conquer the sport in the near future.



Sixteen trotters will gather around the black track of Vincennes in Paris on Sunday (Jan. 19) for the \$723,000 Prix de Cornulier, the premier monté race (trotting under saddle) in the world.

Title defender Bilibili (Niky) recently won the \$144,000 Prix du Calvados in impressive style and the Laurent Claude Abrivard trained 9-year-old will most likely be the first choice in the race that's held over 2,700 meters, approximately 1.6 miles.

Jean-Michel Bazire has hit the bull's eye one more time when it comes to finding the right shape for his horses ahead of the Grand Prix d'Amérique. Last year's winner, Belina Josselyn (Love You), hadn't showed great condition before last Sunday's \$121,800 Prix de Belgique, but just in time, Bazire had the 9-year-old mare at the right spot. quite a tough trip three wide during the race's last 5/8 of a mile, Belina Josselyn sprinted to safe victory in mile rate 1:56.4 over 1.7 miles.

Sylvain Roger trained Enino du Pommereux saved his spot in PdA as runner up while Bazire trained Davidson du Pont (who won the first B-race this winter) finished extraordinary as third.

With one week to go, these trotters are ready for the \$1,002,800 Prix d'Amérique:

Winning is Endeavor's aim

Tom Pollack calls Endeavor one of his favorite horses and it is not difficult to understand why. The 7-year-old male pacer possesses a tough-guy attitude and never-give-in style.

"I call him 'The Big Boy," said Pollack, who owns Endeavor with trainer Jeff Cullipher. "He's kind of a hard-hitting blue-collar lunch-pail-type horse. He's the big, strong, grinding type. He's had very few clunkers, he just gives his all every time."

Endeavor has won 19 of 49 races and \$419,905 in purses for Pollack and Cullipher since they purchased the son of American Ideal—Jett Diamond privately in May 2018. He rose through the conditioned ranks to compete on the Grand Circuit, winning last year's Potomac Pace to go with a second in the Harrah's Hoosier Park Pacing Derby and third in the Dan Patch Stakes.

On Saturday, Endeavor races in the preferred at The Meadowlands. He won his seasonal debut on Jan. 4 at the Big M after finishing an outside-trip second in his 2019 finale.

"He's been sharp, and you hate to shut him down," Pollack said. "We're giving him until he tells us (to stop) and then he'll have a month or two off before we get into the stakes season."

Last year, Endeavor raced in the George Morton Levy Memorial Pacing Series, now called the MGM Borgata Pacing Series, but is unlikely to head to Yonkers Raceway for this season's event.

"We probably did him a disservice putting him in the Levy," Pollack said. "He's a bigger horse and runs in some in the turns. It's not that he can't get around Yonkers, he won a leg of the Levy, but that's not really the best place for him."

Endeavor caught Pollack's eye two years ago when he won a preferred handicap at The Meadowlands. Four months later when the horse became available, he made the purchase. Endeavor was sent to Harrah's Hoosier Park and worked himself up the class ladder. After a seventh-place finish in his debut for his new connections, he won six of his next seven. That included a five-race win streak in which he won each start in 1:49.2 or faster.

"Jeff did a great job with him," Pollack said. "(Endeavor) took

a liking to Hoosier Park and our program. He went on a heck of a run. That's when we knew we were really on to something. Since then, he's been a top-class horse. Capping the year off winning the Potomac Pace was really cool.

"We thought we were buying a nice conditioned racehorse. He just got super sharp and confident and was able to maintain that. It's been great. You love to have horses like him. He gives it his all every time out. There's no cheating in him, that's for sure."

For his career, Endeavor has won 32 of 110 races and \$673,937. Pollack said he expects Endeavor to have a limited Grand Circuit schedule similar to 2019, minus the series at Yonkers.

"He's in the class," Pollack said. "He's probably still a little 1A-ish, but we're looking forward to this year. A lot of the free-for-allers retired so we're going to give him shots, especially on the five-eighths and the mile-track races.

"We'll see how he does this year. We know that as age creeps in it gets tougher. But based on how he's racing now and how he raced at the end of last year he's still got tread on the tires for sure."

Another of the Pollack-Cullipher duo's stakes-winners will be in action Friday at The Meadowlands. Wisdom Tree, a 5-year-old female pacer who was a 2018 New York Sire Stakes champion, is in a conditioned race for fillies and mares. She has won 18 of 49 races and \$618,181 in her career.

"We're probably getting ready to shut her down for a little bit," Cullipher said. "We won't be at every (stakes) dance, but we're going to try to hit our share."

High-five carryover reaches \$100,000 plateau at Big M

On Dec. 27 of last year, one sharp Meadowlands player held the only ticket with the winning combination of 10-6-5-3-9 in the Early 20-cent Jackpot Super High-Five and walked away with \$23,262.20. Were someone to hit the Late JSH5 tonight (Jan. 17), that December payoff would look small by comparison.

The carryover for the wager that requires one to be the lone holder of a ticket with the top five in official order of finish now stands at \$105,787.13. Thus, for a wager of two thin dimes, a player could cash in for over \$100,000 at the conclusion of Friday night's 14thrace.

For those looking for a 20-cent base bet that's a tad easier to hit, the 20-cent Survivor Pick-10 is sure to please. Over the last four race cards at the Big M, the SP10 has returned no less than \$3,526.86. The \$5,022.74 payout on Jan. 10 was interesting because one only had to last five legs to collect. While a 21-1 shot did start the sequence, two of the other four winners went to the gate at 3-1 or less. The 20-cent Survivor Pick-10 begins nightly in the third race.

DEXTER'S BIG SATURDAY:Dexter Dunn became the first driver since Yannick Gingras (Feb. 1, 2019) to win seven times on a Meadowlands program Saturday night. For the weekend (Jan. 10-11), the United States Harness Writers Association's Driver of the Year won eight races in 27 starts, good for a gawdy win percentage of 29.6.

Corey Callahan and Marcus Miller also did well over the two days, scoring four times apiece.

The Big M's big fields and competitive racing led to 26 different trainers winning last weekend, with only Trish Adams and Darren Cassar winning twice.

Cassar's Effronte A – with Dunn driving – took advantage of unseasonably warm conditions, fast fractions and a perfect trip to post the fastest mile of the year in the sport when he stopped the clock in 1:48.3 Saturday night. In fact, that program saw the only four sub-1:50 North American miles of 2020.

PICK-4 REPORT:The Meadowlands' signature wager – the 50-cent Pick-4 – did big business as usual last weekend, with total pools of \$85,813 (Friday) and \$82,539 (Saturday). Friday's payoff of \$226.75 was significant when you consider the last two legs of the wager were taken by 4-5 shots. Saturday's return of \$970.05 started with a 7-5 chalk and ended with the most challenging of the sequence at 12-1.

The wager has a low 15 percent takeout and a guaranteed pool of \$50,000 and is featured nightly on the eighth race.

Friday night's 50-cent Pick-5 returned a whopping \$32,166.95 to a one superb handicapper even though favorites won twice. The wager is offered every night on race one.

This Saturday will mark the second week of the Meadowlands and Woodbine Mohawk Park offering the popular Can-Am Pick-4, where players have to select two winners at each venue to cash. Those who hit a week ago cheered long and loud, as the bet with the 20-cent base returned \$1,413.40.

Last weekend was the third straight where betting exceeded \$5 million at the industry's handle leader, as \$2,773,142 was bet Friday and \$2,594,301 on Saturday.

Extended due date for two Game of Claims Events

After discussion with the Pennsylvania Harness Horsemen's Association, it has been decided to extend the nomination due date for two of the six Game of Claims Late Closing events.


