Toscani nabs Whichwaytothebeach for \$390,000

It was the second highest-priced horse sold in sale history and it came during an auction that set new records for average (\$47,259) and median (\$29,500).

With one significant purchase, Gino Toscani of Mount Hope, ON led the buyers at the Tattersalls Winter Mixed Sale held Monday (Jan. 17) in the paddock at the Meadowlands Racetrack in New Jersey.

Bidding online via ProxiBid, Toscani spent \$390,000 to collar the sale topper, **Hip 77 Whichwaytothebeach**, a 4-year-old gelded son of Somebeachsomewhere out of Swinging Beauty consigned by Bob Boni's Northwood Bloodstock.

"He seems like a nice horse," Toscani told the USTA's Ken Weingartner. "I hope he can come through. He's just going to be 4. His brother, Captain Barbossa, was good as a 4-year-old and hopefully he's going to be the same for us and we can get our money back."

Whichwaytothebeach will be trained by Desiree Jones. It was the second highest sale-topper since at least 2014. The record was set in 2020 when Lindy The Great sold for \$450,000.

Previously trained by Brett Pelling, Whichwaytothebeach earned \$546,425 with a record of 12-6-6 in 27 starts and a mark of 1:49.2.

"He's a legit horse and he was younger than the others. I think that was a big edge," Boni said.

In all, 90 racehorses, stallion shares and breedings collectively sold for \$4,253,300 to produce an average of \$47,259 and a

median of \$29,500. The sale set new records for average and median. This year's auction also set a record for the fewest offerings sold.

"(The record average is) partly a reflection of the number of horses sold, but, on the other hand, it is a fair representation of what we did offer. I was very happy with that," said sale manager David Reid. "It's always exciting to have a live sale, for sure."

This year's gross was up 14 per cent from last year's total of \$3,741,400. The average was up 50 per cent from \$41,244 in 2021 and the median was up 55 per cent from \$19,000 last year.

The record for gross was set in 2018 when 221 horses/stallion shares — 131 more offerings than this year — grossed \$6,694,000.

Northwood also sold **Hip 83 Belmont Major N** to Amanda Kelly of Greenfield Center, NY for \$200,000 — "A very strong price.

The half-mile track miles he showed earlier really helped him a lot," Boni said — and **Hip 67 Ethan T Hanover** for \$115,000 to Matthew Medeirra of Big Z Farm.

Reid's Preferred Equine consigned both the second- and third-highest-priced horses sold — **Hip 56** mare **Swift Swanda** for \$240,000 to Josh Green, agent, of Milford, DE and **Hip 85** 2020 Little Brown Jug winner **Captain Barbossa** for \$210,000 to Robert DiNozzi of Ossining, NY.

"If he's anything like he's been all his career, he'll make money," DiNozzi told Weingartner. "We'll race him at Yonkers a little bit, put him in the Borgata Series, but he's also good on a mile (track) so if he's racing well, we will put him in everything. He's raced with the best and either been competitive or beaten them. There is nothing not to like about the horse."

Preferred Equine sold 51 offerings, grossing \$2,479,200 for an average of \$48,612.

Northwood Bloodstock had 28 sales, grossing \$1,284,600 for an average of \$45,879.

Diamond Creek sold eight for a total of \$428,000, an average of \$53,500.

Reid said he was "very happy with the pre-sale traffic and the at-sale traffic. I was very happy with the attendance. I thought the auctioneers, once again, they are a very talented crew that kept a very good pace to the sale and we continued to offer the online bidding as a convenience to owners that can't make it and it's working out very well.

"I think there were 10 horses sold online today with another 14 (online bidders) ending up the underbidder. Obviously, as a result of the pandemic, we've offered other services and tools. I think the results played in today.

"The other thing I thought was interesting is that on the streaming through www.tattersallsredmile.com there was a point in time today where we had more than 1,000 viewers watching the live stream. For the industry, I think it's great to see the energy and the participation level and it kind of goes off 2021's sale season, which was favorable."

For historical reference, in 2020, the Winter Mixed Sale sold 128 horses/stallion shares for \$5,279,200 to produce an average of

\$41,244 and a median of \$26,500.

In 2019, 150 horses/stallion shares grossed \$4,395,300 for an average of \$29,302 and a median of \$20,000.

In 2018, 221 horses/stallion shares grossed \$6,694,000 for an average of \$30,290 and a median of \$20,000.

In 2017, 233 horses/stallion shares grossed \$6,288,400 for an average of \$26,989 and a median of \$15,000.

In 2016, 258 horses/stallion shares grossed \$5,849,400 for an average of \$22,672 and a median of \$16,500.

In 2015, 269 horses/stallion shares and breedings grossed \$5,971,500, for an average of \$23,291 and a median of \$14,000.

In 2014, the gross of \$5,971,500 for 234 horses/stallion shares produced an average of \$25,519 and median of \$14,000.

In 2013, 206 horses and stallion shares grossed \$4,549,600, an average of \$22,085.

Kings for a weekend

An underexposed portion of harness racing's society stepped squarely into the spotlight last weekend at The Meadowlands as the track paid tribute to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

But this year's event was different. Since 2018, there had annually been one race honoring the civil rights pioneer, but this year there were four, and they took place over the weekend, not just on one night. The races were sponsored by trainer Tony Alagna, and all winners were given a commemorative blanket, trophy and gift basket.

Also, for the first time, and in keeping with Dr. King's message, two of the dashes were multiracial.

"I think he would love to see people coming together because we need that now more than ever before, when we see the condition that the country is in," said New Jersey State Senator Shirley K. Turner. "And people seem to have forgotten Dr. King's philosophy and his message that you don't judge a person by their skin color, you judge them by their character."

Senator Turner was first asked to present the trophy for the 2019 MLK Remembrance Race and has done so ever since.

"I didn't really know that they were going to have a special race in commemoration of his birthday," she said. "But I couldn't wait to get here because I wanted to be here for that august occasion of the celebration of his birthday here at The Meadowlands, in particular because I don't think people think of racing as being a sport where you find minorities participating, African-American



minorities in particular.

"This is something that I feel brings people together here honoring him and it started out much smaller than what it is now. And I think it's significant that it's been expanded at a time when our country needs healing. And Dr. King's message resonates so much more now than ever. I think it's a wonderful occasion to be able to have a race here at The Meadowlands in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King and also to showcase our many African-American drivers."

Driver Jim King Solomon coordinates the race each year working with Meadowlands' race secretary Scott Warren and his predecessor, Peter Koch. Last year, Solomon mentioned that he would like to see more than just African-American drivers competing because that's what Dr. King stood for.

In his iconic "I Have A Dream" speech, Dr. King said, "I have a dream that one day little black boys and girls will be holding hands with little white boys and girls."

That dream was the impetus for the creation of the GSY/MLK race on Friday (Jan. 14) and The Meadowlands Pro/MLK race on Saturday (Jan. 15).

Prior to the race card on Friday, Solomon was interviewed on "In The Sulky," which is part of The Meadowlands pregame show and explained these choices.

"Because Martin Luther King was for everybody, not just for African-Americans," said Solomon. "And that's what we're trying to do."

The GSY Amateur Racing Club competes regularly at The Meadowlands and were happy to support a race in memory of Dr. King.

GSY member Dave Glasser owns only one amateur horse and he was the first to drop in the GSY/MLK race with that horse designated for an MLK driver. Fellow club member James Slendorn did the same.

"Obviously, supporting the legacy of Dr. King in his remembrance race has meaning and I've always tried to teach my kids about not being a bystander and not thinking, oh, other people will do it," said Glasser. "You've got to do the right thing. You've got to walk the walk. You can't just talk. If you want to see good things happen and right things, you have to do them. Be a part of it."

In a speech at Ohio's Oberlin College in the mid-1960s, Dr. King said, "The time is always right to do what's right."

Dave Yarock, GSY club co-founding member, who competed in the GSY/MLK race, was born in 1952 and has memories of Dr. King.

"I remember 1968 and it was a devastating," said Yarock. "First, you had Dr. King and then you had Bobby Kennedy, one, two, and it was like a punch to your sternum. And you said what the hell is going on in this world. It was terrible."

Meadowlands' regular driver Mark MacDonald was pretty happy to win a race honoring Dr. King and he understands the significance of what the great man stood for.

"It hasn't come too far, has it?" said MacDonald. "The division in the country right now is tough. My grandfathers fought in

World War II. You go all the way back and people were fighting different things then. They were fighting Nazi Germany and people weren't getting along and you hate to see the division in any country because it can lead to unrest all over the world."

Driver Devon Tharps, who garnered his first lifetime victory in the 2020 edition of the King Remembrance Race, wore a mic in one of this year's races https://www.facebook.com/meadow-landsracetrack/videos/957531895193593 and even though he didn't win this year, he told The Meadowlands' Jessica Otten that he appreciates the opportunity to compete again at The Big M.

"It definitely means a lot as an African-American to be able to compete, especially on the biggest stage in a race like that for a guy who's done so much for this country and my race," said Tharps. "So, it's definitely special."

Devon's cousin Eric Tharps Jr., who drives nightly at Ohio's Northfield Park, got his first win at The Meadowlands in one of the King races on Saturday.

"It's awesome," said Tharps, Jr. "Without [Dr. King] we wouldn't be able to do any of this. We'd never have the opportunities to do anything of the sort that we can do today. It's not as great as it should be but we're getting by.

"Everything's an opportunity. You've got to seize the moment. You've got to live for what you do and if you love what you do then go out there and get it. Hopefully, people back home see

that I'm capable of driving with the guys and hopefully it leads to more opportunities, more drives, more wins."

A total of 11 African-American drivers – Ray Burton, Jr., Randy Crisler, Michael Cruse, Jamaal Denson, Christopher Petrelli, Newton (Yogi) Sheridan, Solomon, Devon Tharps, Eric Tharps, Jr., Chad Washington and Adrian Wisher, Jr. – competed this year. All the races were competitive and well bet and Solomon has high hopes for the next year.

"If it wasn't for COVID-19 we'd have had more [African-American drivers participate]," said Solomon. "I think we could get 20 next year."







Champion pacer Lochinvar Art returns to the races nearly a year after his last start

Down Under's champion pacer Lochinvar Art is on the verge of a remarkable title defence in one of our greatest races.

When Lochinvar Art won last year's \$A500,000 Group 1 Hunter Cup in Melbourne, it was his 10th win from his past 11 starts and he was the toast of the sport.

He was starting to earn comparisons with some of the all-time greats.

But, as so sadly often happens to the great horses, injury intervened.

Just days after the Hunter Cup, when Lochinvar Art was preparing for a Sydney raid on the \$1Amil Miracle Mile, a nasty hoof abscess emerged. It was to be the start of a nightmare for trainer/driver David Moran.

As Moran raced time to get Lochinvar Art through the setback and into a Miracle Mile lead-up race, he found the abscess had actually spread deeper up the leg and could even be career-threatening.

The biggest star in the game in this part of the world could have run his last race, while on the springboard to eternal greatness.

"It was a scary few weeks. We just couldn't get it under control," Moran said.

Surgery, lots of treatment and a long rehabilitation program later and Lochinvar Art returned to the races last Saturday night (Jan. 15)... 49 weeks after he won that Hunter Cup.

While the son of Modern Art didn't win, it was a victory on so many levels in the eyes of Moran and owner Kevin Gordon.

"You can't ask for any more than that. He did all the work at a crunch stage when the leaders quickened-up. He still forged to the front and it was only late when the effort told and his condition gave out that a lovely horse (Spirit Of St Louis) ran him down," Moran said.

"I knew he was fit, but you can only get them so fit without a race. He'll come on a lot for that."

But can he peak a complete a remarkable back-to-back Hunter Cup victories in less than three weeks from now?

"Based on that run and the fact I'll get another one into him, yes. He's right where I need him now. He thrives on racing. I think he'll be right at his top or very close to it for the Hunter Cup," Moran said.

In a lovely twist of camaraderie, one of Moran's major on track rivals, the man who co-trains and will drive his major Hunter Cup rival, Luke McCarthy, was instrumental on Lochinvar Art's recovery.

"I'm good mates with Luke and he and Belinda (McCarthy's wife) have the most amazing facilities at their place (Cobbitty Equine). They did all the rehab and I couldn't believe how great and forward the horse was when I picked him up about a month ago," Moran said.

Lochinvar Art has beaten McCarthy's superstar King Of Swing at their past two meetings in Victoria's two biggest races, the Hunter Cup and Victoria Cup.

They will lock horns again on Feb. 5.

Oh, and just to add another layer to the resurrection of Lochinvar Art, he also stood his first season at stud, somewhat of a cameo, during his rehab phase with the McCarthys.

"Part of their set-up is a stud farm as well, so we decided to give 'Arty' his chance to serve a few mares as well. He served about 30 I think," Moran said.

Lochinvar Art will have one more lead-up race, either at Ballarat this Saturday or Melton the week after, before chasing one of the most remarkable Hunter Cup wins in the history of the great race.

* * *

It was great to spend a bit of time with the rampaging McCarthy brothers during their time back in Australia.

Andy and Todd McCarthy are headed back to the US with bold ambitions for 2022.

And what's very clear is they now consider the U.S. home and have no plans to move back to Australia any time soon.

"No, it (the U.S.) is home now. Maybe when I retire we might think about moving back to Australia, but that's a long way off. We love it over there, the people are so great," Andy said.

Todd added: "It surprise me a bit how quickly it felt like home to me, too. Sure, I miss family and friends back here, but the States is home for me now. And I can't wait to get back into it.

"It's been a really good, fun few weeks back here and the timing works well, but I had really had some momentum going towards the end of year and there's a lot of horses I can't wait to team up with again."
