Last week I wrote about the Yiddish term "beshert" as it applied to me as a person (full story here). Today, I will address it as it applied to one of the greatest breed-changing stallions in the history of our sport.

As I previously explained, beshert means pre-destined or meant to be.

I'll start at the beginning, or as close to it as this sometimes failing memory allows me to.

Many years ago, Hanover Shoe Farms retained a number of its best-bred fillies to train and eventually enter its broodmare band.

This didn't sit too well with its customers. The feeling, perhaps justifiably, was that Hanover was keeping what they thought were their best fillies and only offering to sell the leftovers.

One of the few good ideas I came up with in my years there was to offer **ALL** of the Farms' fillies to the buying public.

The trick was to still be able to come up with some extra well-bred fillies to replenish the broodmare band.

The plan was to put together a group of well-bred fillies

and pair each with a filly of reasonably comparable quality.

Each pair would enter the ring together. The winning bidder would have his choice of one of the two fillies. The one not chosen would remain the property of Hanover.

This, theoretically, would solve the dilemma. The Farms' customers would have their choice of every filly being sold and Hanover would still be able to retain several choice fillies to become members of its broodmare band.

The plan created a great deal of interest and was very successful. It was abandoned when Hanover decided not to train any more yearling fillies and instead buy older mares either privately or at public auction and offer all of their fillies individually at auction.

In 1984, a member of one of the pairs was an Albatross filly by the name of Wendymae Hanover. She was chosen and purchased by Bill Perretti, if my memory serves me correctly, for the price of \$425,000.

She was, as her price would indicate, absolutely drop dead gorgeous. Not only was she beautiful, but she could fly on the lead strip. She could pace alongside the lead pony faster than any lead pony we had could run.

There was very little doubt, at least in my mind, that she would be the filly of that pair chosen and bought.

She went into training.

There was a problem. Although she exhibited ability, she soon came down with a nagging respiratory problem. It wouldn't go away.


So, they decided to turn her out and bring her back at 3. As a 3-year-old, her problem still persisted. She looked great, but she couldn't get her air properly.

Mr. Perretti's patience gave out and he decided to sell her.

He called John Simpson at Hanover. In his inimitable manner, Wild Bill told him that the filly Hanover had sold him was no good. They discussed (argued) price and I believe the number of \$200,000 was arrived at. It wasn't near what Perretti had paid, but was still a pretty darn good price for a non-record, coming 4-year-old filly with no earnings.

Mr. Simpson decided to put her into training and to try to get a record on her. She exhibited high speed but the breathing problem persisted and she wasn't much of a race mare. She did take a time trial record of 1.56.2, which was pretty good for those days.

Back then, Hanover rarely bred to stallions that they didn't stand. But they had bought a couple of shares in one of the greatest pure speed horses these eyes have ever seen - No Nukes.

Harness Racing Update

The decision was made to breed Wendymae Hanover to No Nukes.

The resultant foal was a beautiful, dark, but medium small colt that they named Western Hanover.

Western Hanover grew into a beautiful yearling. His only blemish was a capped hock.

George Segal, accompanied by his trustful trainer and yearling picker, Gene Riegle, would visit Hanover, almost always, on the day after the Little Brown Jug to get a line on the Hanover offering right before the Kentucky sales.

Back then, Hanover had an airplane and Gene and George would hitch a ride with us to get an inkling of what we had to sell.

Bear in mind that the Hanover yearlings had just been in for a couple of weeks and were just barely civilized at the time.

But Riegle, arguably as good a yearling picker as there ever was, did not need a horse to look spit and polished to pick a good one out.

One of the remarkable things about Riegle that I found distinguished him from most other trainers was that there was no template that described what he would like in a yearling.

Although he was very picky, he could find horses big or small, short or tall that he liked or more often did not like.

Segal later told me that on the ride home that Riegle said to him words to the effect that, "Whatever you buy in Lexington, George, save some money for that little No Nukes colt at Hanover." Segal then asked him, "What about the capped hock and isn't he too small?"

Riegle said, "Don't worry about either. He will be alright."

Segal ended up buying him for \$105,000. The underbidder was Alan Katz of the 3 Brothers Stable. If Katz would have

got him, he would have been trained by Brett Pelling.

Western Hanover was shipped to Brittany farms before he went into training at Ben White Raceway in Orlando.

Art Zubrod told me that the first few times he was turned out in the paddock at Brittany, he cleared the fence. He didn't run away. He just decided that he liked the grass on the other side better. He also did this the second and third times, even after he had been given a tranquilizer, before he got the idea that he was supposed to stay where he was.

When they bought Western, Zubrod had very much suspected that they had bought a great athlete. Now he knew it for sure.

Shortly afterwards, he was shipped to Riegle's stable.

All winter long, Western Hanover was afflicted with the same problem that had affected his mother when she was a 2-year-old. He was mildly sick. Nothing serious. But it was a nagging respiratory problem that didn't go away until the end of winter.


Consequently, he was brought along slowly.

He didn't even qualify until early August. But that didn't stop him from winning the richest and then most prestigious Canadian Stakes event for 2-year-olds, the Prix de l'Avenir at Blue Bonnets Raceway, the next week.

From that point forward, just about all he did was win. Despite the late start, he was still voted the freshman pacing colt of the year for 1991.

His 3-year-old season started somewhat the same way as his 2-year-old year ended. He was undoubtedly the best colt out there, but he was beset by misfortune in some of the big races. He didn't win either the Meadowlands Pace nor the Little Brown Jug. He was still voted the sophomore pacing colt of the year for 1992.

When I think back to him, I sometimes think of this past

year's best 3-year-old pacer Bettors Wish. He was undoubtedly the best, but he didn't win some of the big ones.

Let's switch gears and return to the previous year -1991.

The sport had a great trio of 3-year-old pacers in Artsplace, Die Laughing and Precious Bunny.

Artsplace was the most attractive, but he was all tied up. Segal had decided to stand him at Southwind Farms in New Jersey.

Precious Bunny lacked impressive 2-year-old credentials and was a son of BG's Bunny who Mr. Simpson did not think that highly of.

That left Die Laughing, who seemingly had it all.

He was very good at both 2 and 3. He was a gorgeous colt. He was a son of No Nukes who was then as hot as a stallion could be and was from a great maternal family.

There was one problem, though. There was an ongoing feud between the Chasonoffs, the half owners of Die Laughing, and John Simpson. Marty Granoff owned the other half, but the Chasanoffs appeared to be the managing partners with Marty having little or no say.

It's been so long that I don't even remember the genesis of the feud. But there were definitely hard feelings involved.

Mr. Simpson said, "Jimmy (Simpson) and you can go see them and see if they are interested in working out a deal. I still don't like them, but I won't stand in the Farm's way of getting a stallion that we can use."

Jim Simpson and I went to visit with Mickey Chasanoff and his son Bobby at their building complex in Jericho Long Island.

We were well received and ironed out the beginnings of a deal that would have brought Die Laughing to Hanover.

A stallion contract was put together. I recall Bobby

Chasanoff asking for a list of prospective broodmares that Hanover could breed to Die Laughing. I dutifully sent a list of about 50 mares to him.

Everything appeared to be set. Hanover Shoe Farms was going to be the home of Die Laughing. I recall getting a phone call from Marty Granoff. He was enthused. He said his dream was to have a horse worthy of standing at the greatest name in harness racing.

Then, at the last moment, the Chasanoffs put a wheel under us.

They wanted the right to reject any owner of a mare who for any reason that they did not like from breeding to Die Laughing.

Hanover's response was, "That's not the way we do business. Our job is to give the horse the best opportunity possible. We are not about to turn down a good mare or insult our reliable customers, because, for whatever reason, the Chasanoffs do not want us to book their mare to Die Laughing."

The deal went down in flames.

We know the result. The horse went to stud at Fair Winds Farm in New Jersey. Through no fault of Fair Winds, he turned out to be an abject failure or pretty close to it.

Let's now return to 1992. Paul E Spears, John Simpson's successor as president of Hanover Shoe Farms, was at The Meadowlands a few days before that year's Hambletonian.

I was with him when we were approached by George Segal, who asked us if we were free for lunch the next day.

He had something he wanted to discuss with us.

We met for lunch at Union Square Cafe in New York City.

Segal wanted Hanover to stand and syndicate Western Hanover. We needed a stallion, especially a son of No Nukes, although we had missed out on the one that we most really

wanted.

We were interested.

Western Hanover finished the racing year quite well, although with a disappointing loss in the Little Brown Jug that really bothers me to this day.

The job now was to syndicate him and gather as good a group of mares for him as we possibly could.

That proved to be quite difficult.

Western Hanover was regarded as a very good horse, but few thought of him as being a great one.

The expectations were not that high.

A couple of the noted, self-proclaimed mavens of the day derisively referred to him as "Little Ralph", comparing his future in the stud to the failure of Ralph Hanover.

The general frame of mind was that he'd be okay as a stallion, but not great.

To the public he was regarded as lacking that blazing speed that horses like his father No Nukes and maternal grandfather Albatross possessed.

The only person I remember who felt that the horse would become a great stallion was Hanover's general manager Dr. Peter Boyce.

Boyce had been a huge fan of the horse from the time he was foaled. His confidence in him never wavered. He was sure that he'd become a great stallion.

Just about every commercial breeder and many mom and pop breeders were contacted about buying shares in Western Hanover. Only one single share was sold, that one to All American Harnessbreds. Everybody else passed.

The huge irony is that many of those breeders first approached, later bought shares in him for multiples of the original buying price.

Hanover and Segal realized that they had a problem.

They would support the horse, but that their support alone might not be enough.

The decision was made to stand him at the low stud fee of \$4,000, a price that would be irresistible to some.

Even with that low stud fee, very few commercial breeders bred to him.

His book did fill. But for the most part, aside from Hanover and Brittany, it consisted of average mom and pop mares.

The only maiden mare he got from Hanover and maybe in his entire book was Rich N Elegant. That was before she became **RICH N ELEGANT**. She was a nice mare that we had bought through Bob Boni for \$12,000.

From that mating of course came the top colt Rustler Hanover, sending both Western Hanover and Rich N Elegant on their respective ways to greatness.

From that point in time, Western Hanover was off and running and became one of the greatest sires the breed has ever known.

Do you think that isn't bashert?


If Hanover had got Die Laughing, there is almost no chance that they would have stood Western Hanover.

We lost out on a horse that we really wanted, who to a great degree would have caused great harm to Hanover's broodmare band and its reputation. Instead, we got our second choice who turned out to become one of the sport's greatest all time sires.

That is beshert.

Touting some of the best from the Winter Mixed Sale catalogue

Preferred's David Reid and Northwood's Bob Boni shine a light on some of the notable horses they are selling Monday at The Meadowlands.

With the Tattersalls Winter Mixed Sale on tap on Monday afternoon (Jan. 20) at the Meadowlands, the two biggest consignors - Preferred Equine and Northwood Bloodstock took some time to tout a few of their offerings to HRU.

The sale, which starts at noon on the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday in the Big M paddock, will see some 130 head, as well as about 20 stallion shares offered. For complete details, visit:http://www.tattersallsredmile.com.

David Reid said his Preferred consignment is pleased to offer, "probably the best horse that's in the sale —**Lindy The** Great (Hip #126). He's a well-bred, good-looking horse that won the Caesar's Trotting Classic last year, defeating some of the best trotters in the business. He qualified back very strong last week in :52.3 here at the Meadowlands with a last quarter in :26.1."

Preferred is also selling a French mare named Chanced'Occagnes (Hip #11), a Ready Cash mare out of Quiet Mary that is in foal to Muscle Hill.

"She came from Europe and has been here since December." Reid said. "There's some interest in that mare. She'll be fun to sell."

Preferred also has three Ontario-bred 2-year-old, "that are broke and going, and the consignor has provided videos of those."

They will sell in succession as Hip #43 - Crown Patent (a Sebastian K filly out of Whitesand Samantha), Hip #44 - Hail To Reason (an Angus Hall filly out of Queen Nora) and Hip #45 - Infinity Stone (an Il Songo Dream colt out of Magic Factory).



Lindy The Great is expected to be one of the top horses Preferred Equine will sell Monday at the Tattersalls Winter Mixed Sale at The Meadowlands.

"Then we get into the racehorses," Reid said. "We have some race mare that also give good breeding value as well, including the warhorse Witch Dali (Hip #66), everybody knows her. Then there's Make Mine Mocha (Hip #76) and the well-bred filly Jezzys Legacy (Hip #73), an interesting trotting mare out of the great Jezzy.

"Then, there's the group of 4-year-olds, Union Forces (Hip #81) is a nice prospect. Western Exposure (Hip #82), Captain Malicious (Hip #86) – he's out of the Ray Schnittker barn. Captain Trevor (Hip #88) was a :49 winner last year and he qualified (at the Meadowlands Friday) morning.

Escapetothebeach (Hip #93), here's another high-end pacer and one of the better colts last year. He qualified (at the Meadowlands Friday) morning and he looks like he's ready for a good season.

"Then, in the older division, **Trolley (Hip #111)** is a proven trotter... We had another horse that won his qualifier (Friday) morning, **Bicorne Hanover (Hip #146)**. He won in :52 flat and it was not-a-nice morning. That was a good update there."

Reid said there will also be a number of nice stallion shares offered by Preferred.

"We have multiple shares of Captaintreacherous and multiple shares of Muscle Hill, which is top of the market. We have a share of Father Patrick and other quality horses as well," he said.

BONI'S BEST

Northwood Bloodstock's Bob Boni highlighted six horses from his consignment.

"Hip #5, Valley Makayla, is an interesting mare. She's a Donato Hanover in foal to Tactical Landing in his first crop and she's already a stakes producer. Donato Hanover, obviously his mares have produced no less than Greenshoe, so I think we've got a little bit of a star here," Boni said. "Her first two foals have both done some good on the stakes level and she's carrying what seems to be an attractive horse from what have sold, so far. She's also dual-eligible. She's also eligible for the Kentucky program.

"On the racehorses, **Hip #60 Pilgrims Lass**. She's a stakes winner by Muscle Mass. She's got a record of :55 and change. She's made almost \$90,000. A pretty good filly. She made over \$50,000 last year. She's from the family of Perfect Spirit, a Hambletonian winner. She'd be a nice mare both race and breeding-wise. She could sell foals. She has a good page."

Boni said "Hip #68, Art Lecture, is a very nice horse with a

connection to Papi Rob Hanover.

"She's a Well Said. She won in :52.3 as a 3-year-old last year at Yonkers. She's a stakes winner. She made almost \$150,000. She made \$60,000 plus last year. She's a very handy mare and she's got some pedigree. She's also a sister to Art History and goes back to the family of Papi Rob Hanover."

Boni next mentioned Hip #92, Deplorable Tom.

"He's got a new record of :54.1 that he got in very late December. He's made over \$50,000. He's a nice-looking, young trotter. He's a 4-year-old. He's won, two of his last three, but he'll make a nice horse for somebody."

Northwood is also selling **Hip #119, Doctor Butch**, a winner of \$1,563,207lifetime.

"He just qualified yesterday. He made almost \$70,000 last year," Boni said. "He's obviously a significant stakes winner. He's from a sister to Yankee Cruiser. He's got pedigree, he's got everything. He's a great half-mile track horse. He's been test bred and he has an exceptional initial fertility test. So, he's got a market somewhere for somebody. Obviously, he's a racehorse because he was second in a qualifier (Friday) night at Yonkers off a layoff from November. He's fresh and ready to go and he offers both aspects."

Finally, Boni mentioned **Hip #122, For A Dreamer**as, "a very nice son of Cantab Hall that made over \$50,000 last year, winning in :53 at the Meadowlands. The last few days in December he won in :54.1 at the Meadowlands. He's racing well. He has a win and a second in his last two starts and has a big pedigree. He is a very nice horse that will fit in just about anywhere. Lifetime he's a winner of over \$150,000. He is a legitimate horse."

Reid, acting in his role as general manager of the sale, said he's "very happy with the overall quality of the horses (being sold). The number of entries are down slightly over last year, but the overall quality is better. Right across a broad selection of categories. The broodmares, we've got in foal to proven, commercial sires, like Always B Miki, Father Patrick and Captaintreacherous. We've got a couple mares in foal to the first crop of Tactical Landing.

"The industry knows that the racehorse market is tight right now. We've had good interest in the sale and we expect to do a fair-market sale and we're looking forward to getting them sold. We have a lot of promising lots to sell."

For the record, I don't believe in hexing horses.

Wind and overcast skies prevailed on Friday morning. Even with the inclement weather and just a few viewers on The Deck, the mood was upscale, elevated by both the good horses and the realization that we are quite likely to have sports betting at racetracks in Kentucky. The vote to send the bill to the Kentucky legislature had no descenting parties. The word on the street is that as of today it is likely to pass and then shortly thereafter be signed into law by the governor. This will represent another major positive to the harness racing community. I will give updates on the progress of the passage in my Ask the Guru column next Friday.

I am not a believer of the idea that if you write good things about a horse or predict a good future for a horse it is a hex and will ruin his career. That's an old wives tale.

That said, Freddy Grant had two very talented colts that I wrote about last year that due to some issues never reached their full potential. Freddy will tell you that they had some problems not caused by my column. Therefore I will have another go at it.

The first two horses that caught my eye Friday morning came from the Grant barn. Fred trained **Island Lilly** a Chapter Seven filly out of Up Front Hotsey and talented assistant Frode Fladen had **PowerplayGoal** a Muscle Mass colt from Finesse Hanover, a colt I loved as a yearling, loved training last year and was a six-figure purchase. Freddy said they are a pair of green 3-year-olds that he was high on last year and feels that they are stakes caliber horses at some level if they stay together.

I didn't see much of the Alagna group go, but a few I liked were **Choir Master**, a colt by Mach Three out of Ideal Helen, **It's Showtime** a Captaintreacherous colt from the good mare Uffizi Hanover and **Rollnthejoe** a colt by Roll With Joe from Sweet Bonnie.

The highlight of the morning was Matt Krueger's exclamation "can you believe Tony actually let me cut a mile?"

Domenico Cecere and his Lindy Farm group had a busy morning as Frank M. Antonacci was a visiting trainer. Looking particularly good were **Captain Terror**, a Captaintreacherous colt from Pink Terror, **Lindy At The Beach** a Somebeachsomewhere filly out of Lindys Nightmare, and **Gai Waterhouse** p. 2, 150.3 \$171,812, a wonderful stakes-winning daughter of Western Ideal from the good Brittany Farm mare The Art Museum.

On Saturday, the weather was not much improved, and began colder with more wind.

It was an excellent morning for some big-ticket colts. My top three of the day were: **Maverick** the million-dollar full-brother to Greenshoe from the Alagna barn and driven by Tony, **Goodashim Hanover**, the \$240,000 full-brother to Greenshoe's sire Father Patrick, driven by Jimmy Takter for Domenico Cecere and Lindy Farms and **Abuckabett Hanover** a colt by Betting Line from the Western Ideal mare All Tucked Up a \$160,000 Harrisburg yearling trained and driven by Alagna.

Megan Scran owns and trains **Farspeak** a 3-year-old Artspeak colt from This Fool Rocks who looked like a bargain at \$14,000.

From Webster/Croghan came a wonderful group of 2-year-olds co-owned by Dana Parham and Let It Ride Stable. The very athletic duo of **Bang Bang** (I love the name) a Sweet Lou filly out of Jolting Kate and **Totally Rusty**, a Rustys For Real filly from Rustys Joy, looked great.

Bardmiry, a Sweet Lou filly from Quick Babe, I'm Sponge Worthy, a Somebeachsomewhere colt from Love Canal, Shameless Bluechip a Betting Line filly from Fox Valley Shaker and Seeyoubye Bluechip, a Sweet Lou filly out of Lotsa Matzah, all were very nice.

A trio of fine 2-year-olds from Travis Alexander were **Nine Mile Marla**, a Class Included filly from Stormont Catchme, **Bank Examiner**, an Uncle Peter filly from Examination and **Indian Caviar**, a Triumphant Caviar colt out of Keystone India.

David McDuffee watched **Creedom** the Swan For All filly out of the Muscle Hill mare Cree that he pushed Lindy Farms to \$95,000 on the last night of the Lexington sale and remarked what a great gait she has, as well as pedigree.

Horse of the Year bridesmaids are horse too

A look at some of the most memorable Horse of the Year runners-ups in the 20th century.

In 1947, Hoot Mon was second to his stablemate Victory Song in year one of the Horse of the Year award — 165-160 in the voting . Sep Palin and Castleton Farm had both. The polling was conducted by the Trotting Horse Club Of America. Fifty sports editors and radio commentators voted. Runner-sup Hoot Mon furthered his reputation by siring the first horse ever to win the HOY back to back — Scott Frost in 1955-1956. For trivia fans, he was the first runner-up to sire a HOY runner-up too, as Scott Frost as a 2 YO in 1954 actually got more first place votes than winner Stenographer but was second best on total points.

In 1948, Rodney (398-340) won it over Hambletonian winner Demon Hanover. Harrison Hoyt, who drove Demon Hanover, almost gave the amateur drivers the HOY, something that Mal Burroughs would do in 1997 with Malabar Man, who, like Demon Hanover, also captured the Hambletonian.

In 1955, Scott Frost posted the sport's first ever Triple Crown, and this was year one of his back-to-back HOY titles. Adios Harry had the place spot, something he would do in 1956 also marking the only time in the 73-year history of the HOY balloting that the same two would finish 1-2 in consecutive years in order.

In 1957, Torpid won the HOY over Galophone — 724 to 208. Sixty-seven of the 84 responders went his way. In the 3YOCP division, Torpid dominated 249-3 over a colt named Meadowlands. John Simpson, Sr. handled the winner.

In 1958, the first tie occurred with Belle Acton and Emilys Pride tied at 28 votes each. The latter, the Hambletonian winner, would get the decision on points 438-407, marking the first time female horses went 1-2. Being second best for Team Haughton would happen a couple of more times before they eventually broke through in 1977 with their first of two HOY awards — Green Speed. Nihilator followed for the Haughtons in 1985.

In 1960, The Butler did it. For the first of two straight HOY titles, 1960 was the year of Adios Butler, who despite the Triple Crown of 1959, was second best to Bye Bye Byrd in '59.

In 1960, only 13 voters (83/96) did not put the "Butler" on top. He also failed to get 13 votes in 1961 (100-113). In 1961, Su Mac Lad was second best.

In 1962, Stanley Dancer went 1-2 for the first of two times. Su Mac Lad bested Henry T Adios.

In 1963, Speedy Scot won the HOY. He would be second the following year when the Bret Hanover Express took off. Overtrick was second in 1963.

In 1964, Bret Hanover went 24-for-24 and received 70 first place votes from the 185 who returned ballots. Ayres won the Trotting Triple Crown but did so in the wrong year as far as HOY. Speedy Scot was second best.

In 1965, Bret Hanover was in the middle of his threepeat. Bret Hanover defeated Hambletonian runner-up Armbro Flight.

In 1966, Bret Hanover won his third straight HOY vote. Romeo Hanover, who won the Triple Crown, was good enough for second.

In 1967, 2-year-old Nevele Pride was an incredible 26-for-29 and took the first of what would become the only trotting HOY threepeat. Romulus Hanover was second in the vote.

In 1968, Billy Haughton won his only Triple Crown as Rum Customer was victorious. But Rum Customer was no match in the HOY voting for the other Triple Crown winner, the dominant Nevele Pride. This marked the only year that standardbred racing sported two Triple Crown winners.

In 1969, Nevele Pride was the HOY again, yet five others out-earned him. Nevele Pride \$222,876):

#1 Overcall - \$373,150

#2 Lindys Pride - \$323,997 (Triple Crown winner)

#3 Laverne Hanover - \$290,668

#4 Fresh Yankee - \$255,288

#5 Une De Mai - \$234,882

Nevele Pride won the HOY vote 133-56 with unblemished Overcall second.

In 1970, a colt named Albatross, just 2, placed fourth on the HOY ticket, an award he would garner the next two years. He won his freshman division 203-1. Fresh Yankee won the HOY at age 7. The trotting mare would race another couple of seasons and retire the first North American-bred trotter to \$1 million. Triple Crown winner and later dominant stallion Most Happy Fella was second in the voting, from the first crop of Meadow Skipper.

In 1971, Albatross in the first of a two-year stretch for the ages was the HOY. Steady Star was second best, aided by his world record 1:52 time trial.

In 1972, it was Albatross again. Stanley Dancer became the only trainer to have back-to-back HOYS on each gait. Super Bowl was second best off his Triple Crown season.

In 1973, Sir Dalrae won the HOY 87-7 over Hambletonian winner Flirth with 187 of 216 votes going the way of the Jim Dennis trainee. Odd note, of the 29 that did not vote for Sir Dalrae, they spread out their vote with 14 different horses.

In 1974, Delmonica Hanover won with the lowest ever percentage of votes — 24.8 per cent. Forty-eight votes went her way out of 194 cast. She won the Prix d'Amérique which likely decided the HOY as she was victorious only four other times. Armbro Nesbit was second, fresh off his 1:56.4 track record at Yonkers. Sixteen different horses got at least one first place vote.

In 1975, Silk Stocking was second to Savoir in the closest HOY vote ever 52-49. The 7-year-old gelding won over the 3-year-old filly pacing sensation. He was second in the 1971 Hambletonian won by Speedy Crown before Silk Stocking was foaled. She won the then richest race ever the \$230,531 Monticello OTB Classic in 1975.

In 1976, Keystone Ore won over Keystone Pioneer. It was Dancer's seventh and last HOY. Sixteen different horses got first place votes, with Ore defeating Pioneer 130-31. This final bridesmaid finish for Team Haughton would come the year before they broke through in 1977 with Green Speed.

In 1977, Green Speed dominated and gave Haughton his first HOY title, nine years after he went into the Hall Of Fame. Governor Skipper was the HOY runner-up.

In 1978, Abercrombie won over Speedy Somolli, the latter siring the first New Jersey-bred to win the Hambletonian — Nuclear Kosmos. Abercrombie sired the 1992 HOY Artsplace who rolled through a 16-16 season.

In 1979, Niatross was victorious. Nobody has been named HOY at ages 2 and 3 since. Hot Hitter, whose \$826,52 bankroll was the single season all-time best to that point, was second in the HOY voting.

In 1980, Niatross defeated French Chef 238-1. But they both sired single-season earnings record holders — Nihilator in 1985 for Niatross and Beach Towel in 1990 for French Chef.

In 1982, Cam Fella burst upon the scene. He would win the HOY award in back to back seasons. In '82 he defeated Genghis Khan who became the first horse to better 1:53 and 1:52 in the same season.

In 1983, Ralph Hanover's Triple Crown and \$1,711,990 was not enough to derail Cam Fella in the HOY voting. The latter won 30 of 36 including his final 28 in a row.

In 1984, Fancy Crown won over On The Road Again in what would be the first of two straight HOY runner-up finishes for OTRA. Bill O'Donnell drove the winner for Ted Andrews, and she was part of a day (8/16/84) where the Magic Man piloted 10 winners, five by day and another five by night, included in there were two HOYs and the richest race of all time, the \$2,161,000 Woodrow Wilson.

In 1985, Nihilator became Billy Haughton's first pacer to be named HOY when he defeated On The Road Again, who briefly held the earnings title. The HOY runner-up was a \$10,500 yearling for Harry Poulton and Buddy Gilmour and also Pacer Of The Year runner-up both years (1984-1985)

In 1986, the battle of the undefeateds had Forrest Skipper defeat Jate Lobell in a year when they were 31-for-31 combined.

In 1987, John Campbell won his first HOY with Mack Lobell, who was also the 1988 winner. Jate Lobell was second again.

In 1989, Peace Corps was second in her sophomore year of 1989 176-71 to Matts Scooter. Peace Corps earned \$4,137,737 in her career. Four Breeders Crowns was her total — unprecedented. How dominant was she among the trotters of 1989? She was named Trotter Of The Year 249-3 over Valley Victory and Scenic Regal (tie).

In 1990, Beach Towel dominated over No Sex Please 273-13. Two years earlier, No Sex Please was the only 3-year-old in the March Of Dimes Trot at Garden State Park.

In 1991, Giant Victory was telescopically second to Precious Bunny 270-10 giving the Meadowlands Pace winner the HOY title over the Hambletonian winner.

In 1992, one 1/3 vote? Really? In the 3YOCT category, someone thought this was okay.

Alf Palema — 189.3 Sierra Kosmos — 69.3 Baltic Striker — 19 King Conch — 11.3

Anyway, Artsplace took off with the title, and his stablemate from 1991. Western Hanover, was second 243-30. (Gene Riegle had both in 1991, Bob McIntosh took over the training of Artsplace in 1992 for the pacer's unblemished 16-for-16 season).

In 1993, Staying Together won the HOY over Presidential Ball thanks, in part, to a 1:48.2 new world record down a full second from the prior year's 1:49.2 from HOY Artsplace. Career earnings of \$2.2 million for Presidential Ball made him the richest ever pacer not to be named HOY.

In 1995, it was CR Kay Suzie over Jennas Beach Boy. This was the first of two straight years JBBwould be HOY runner-up to a 3YOFT.

In 1996, Continentalvictory became the last filly of the 20th century to win the Hambletonian. Trainer Joe Holloway had both the Older Pacing division winners that year — Jennas Beach Boy and She's A Great Lady. Jenna was Pacer of the Year over Mystical Maddy 100-65 and She's A Great Lady the Pacing Mare of the Year 216-6 over Ellamony.

In 1997, it was a HOY no go for Triple Crown winner Western Dreamer, who had to settle for second honors to the dominant Malabar Man (16 13-3-0) the first trotter to average over \$100G per start.

In 1998, Moni Maker won the HOY. She would be the winner again in 1999 and second in 2000. Muscles Yankee was second best in the year-end tally 125-90.

In 1999, once again the Triple Crown was not parlayed into a HOY. Blissfull Hall led in earnings \$1,328,819, but could not derail the international star named Moni Maker.











Death by a Salesman (Part 1)

Our mission this morning was to fetch an old black Franklin stove from the *Junk in the Trunk* Antique shop. The stove job gave me a chance to test-drive my latest delusion with my wealthy patron.

"True."

"Of course, you should begin marketing stallions immediately."

"Thank you. Let me begin with a question. How much did you pay for your plane ticket to London where you boarded the ship for your cruise around the world?"

He shrugged, "Honestly, I don't know. An agency handled my arrangements."

"A few years ago, using an Internet sale and traveling with a backpack, I flew first class, round trip New York to London for \$287. A friend was working at the ticket counter, we hugged and chatted, she winked, pushed a few buttons, and upgraded me. Her move was possibly prohibited, but you notice I am not using her last name. Besides, this first-class seat remained unsold, so nobody got hurt."

"What does this have to do with stallion bookings?"

"Somewhere above Iceland, after his third complimentary cocktail, the man across the aisle leaned over and slurred that he was on this way to a convention of coal mining equipment contractors. Then he bragged that his seat cost \$1,900."

"Airline tickets and stallion breeding contracts are not the same animals."

"Trey, I'm sure there is a lot more involved in pricing a stallion and selling a breed contract -psychology, groupthink, connections, preferences, resales, state programs..."

"Thank you, Mister Dictionary. None of those is what I mean. Let's say a wise owner gives Trey free rein with a test stallion."

"He will be sorry, but proceed."

"My first move will be to double, maybe triple, the currently listed stud fee. We will equal or surpass the top-priced

stallion in the state. In January and February, the advertised fee for this stallion is \$10,000. Literature and Breaking News will proclaim the new price. The price will not change, ever. I would spread the word via an online publication, "NEW PRICE, Breeding will go FAST, book now before the supply is gone." This faux news lies somewhere between marketing and a whopper (after all, this a NEW price and FAST is a relative term).

"Relatively speaking, you are out of your mind."

"That price is not the point. For the rest of his stud life, \$10,000 is his brand."

"Nobody would pay that much."

"I would insist that the owner of the stallion breed a minimum of three mares to the stallion and secretly pay himself or herself ten grand to prove it is possible. After those breedings are on the books, not many customers will follow; perhaps a few ridiculously rich people, an alcoholic person in a weak moment, people who love this stallion, maybe a stray French person, and maybe a stray person with a sense of whimsy."

"So your brilliant marketing idea is to hope for a stray buyer. Is this all you do all day, think of crazy plans?"

"Well, on the bright side, I'm not a crack addict."

"They may say it. Trey doesn't buy it. Purchasing semen from a stallion is a ridiculous concept. We are buying dreams. Everyone should have the illusion that they make a great deal when they sign a breeding contract."

"Well, to be honest, I don't think what you are suggesting is a revolutionary marketing concept."

We pulled into *Junk in the Trunk*. "Of course not, but I'm just getting started selling semen to people with a broodmare and an open mind. When we get back in the car, I will make this increased pricing madness look sane." s

Gural: Disappointing that we have to beg people

While I appreciate Brett Sturman's story last week about how the Meadowlands drives the industry (full story here), with almost all of the \$48 million increase in handle for the year coming from the Meadowlands as a result of the purse subsidy, I find it very frustrating that we continually have to beg people who have benefited by the decision I made to step up at the last minute after the Governor announced that the State would no longer continue to operate the facility since it was losing \$10 million a year.

It is very discouraging that year after year we literally have to beg people who have benefitted to help us by sponsoring a stakes race. We offer almost \$15 million in stakes and \$4.5 million comes from the purse account along with sponsorships. Essentially, our goal is to raise \$600,000 in sponsorships and when we come up short we have to make up the shortfall from the overnight purse account. The same people year after year have been very generous in their support and, conversely, the same people year after year who are selling yearlings at prices far higher than previously refuse to help the cause. I believe that this should be a team effort as, until sports betting arrived, I was personally funding the losses of \$2-3 million a year in order to keep the lights on.

I've asked Jason Hall to reach out one last time to those people who are benefiting from our stakes program in an effort to raise the \$600,000 we have budgeted to sponsorships. I have to believe that one of the main reasons that yearling prices increased so dramatically is that with the subsidy the Meadowlands is now in a position to offer higher purses and a much higher quality-racing product. I doubt we would be seeing yearlings selling for a million dollars if the Governor had succeeded at closing the Meadowlands.

The AGCO in Ontario should be more aggressive and harsher penalties must be enforced not just for drugs but for these lackadaisical drives which have become the norm. This modus operandi of chemist trainers and lackadaisical drives has emptied the stands at racetracks across the country and the people will never come back until the racetracks and the authorities who are supposed to be policing the sport wake up and do their job. If not the federal government is going to see a rise in unemployment that they just elected with a minority have never experienced and it will be a fiasco.
