Prominent harness racing trainer and thoroughbred owner Nick Surick was sentenced Thursday (Jan. 19) to five years and two months in prison for his involvement in what the Justice Department says is the biggest horse-doping investigation in its history.

The sentencing took place in U.S. District Court in New York, where prison sentences have been meted out to 18 other defendants in the case. Prosecutors have charged 31 individuals since March 2020.

Surick, 34, of Jackson, NJ, wore a suit and tie to court and showed no reaction as the punishment was handed down by Judge Mary Kay Vyskocil. It was one of the harshest sentences to come out of the FBI probe. Probation officials recommended a sentence of six years.

Surick agreed to plead guilty to three felonies as part of a cooperation deal with prosecutors. He began cooperating shortly after his arrest nearly three years ago with most of

the other defendants. He told Vyskocil it was tough to provide incriminating information about close friends and business associates but said it was the right thing to do.

He said he was sorry for the crimes he committed. "I hurt the sport I love," he said.

He apologized to "hardworking" trainers, "the horses themselves," and regulators.

"I owe an apology to the public," he added. "They were gambling on a product that was not true."

Surick added, "I was caught up in this crazy competition to be the best. I lost my way."

Even though Surick ratted out others in the racing industry, federal prosecutors declined to provide him with a so-called 5K1 letter recommending leniency.

"The Government has concluded that the defendant has not provided substantial assistance in any investigation or prosecution," prosecutor Sarah Mortazavi wrote in court papers last week ahead of the sentencing.

"This decision was precipitated by the defendant's inaccurate recounting of a pivotal event involving the doping of a particular horse, Northern Virgin, which was included in a superseding charging instrument on the basis of Surick's description," she said.

Mortazavi said Surick told prosecutors that co-defendant Rebecca Linke, a veterinarian, had personally injected Northern Virgin with the banned substance Epogen in December 2018 when in fact Surick had injected the horse himself. Linke received a deferred prosecution agreement from the prosecution.

In court, Mortazavi said that Surick's incorrect version of what happened so compromised his credibility that prosecutors were unable to use the information he provided to charge anyone else.

Still, she said prosecutors did not believe Surick lied and that it did not warrant ripping up the cooperation agreement. She said Surick still deserved credit for attempting to cooperate at an early point in the case.

In court Surick said to Vyskocil that he had no reason to lie. He blamed a faulty memory for what happened.

"It's an honest mistake that destroyed the 5K," he said.

Surick choked up as he asked the judge to sentence him to home confinement.

"I just want to keep going straight," he said. "I am hoping and praying you give me the chance."

"This case is somewhat unique, and for the court a difficult case," Vyskocil said. But she said it was necessary to sentence Surick to prison for his crimes.

"By plying horses with PEDs you endangered horses, other horses, jockeys, and drivers," Vysckocil said. She said he cheated regulators and the betting public.

"You impugned the integrity of the sport," the judge told Surick.

She said Surick was different from other defendants because he had been charged with obstruction for impeding New Jersey Racing Commission investigators from testing Northern Virgin after he had been doped with Epogen.

Surick and prosecutors memorialized the cooperation agreement in October 2020 when Surick appeared before Vyskocil and pleaded guilty to two counts of conspiracy to misbrand and adulterate drugs and one count of obstruction. The maximum penalty for those three charges is 30 years in prison.

One of the conspiracy counts related to the doping of horses trained by Jorge Navarro, who is serving a five-year sentence in the case.

The other conspiracy count related to Surick's doping of his own horses.

Surick was the one prosecutors say was captured on a wiretap claiming to have made horses that Navarro "killed...disappear."

"You know how many f----- horses he (Navarro) f----- killed and broke down that I made disappear," Surick was quoted as saying to co-defendant trainer Michael Tannuzzo in February 2019. "... You know how much trouble he could get in...if they found out ... The six horses that we killed."

Mortazavi wrote that during the proffer sessions with prosecutors, Surick minimized his conversation with Tannuzzo.

Surick attorney Timothy Donohue of West Orange, NJ, said about the conversation that it concerned how "broken-down horses" were disposed of by selling them to purchasers in Pennsylvania.

In 2017 Surick trained the 1,000th winner of his career at

Freehold Raceway, according to reports. Two years later, he won 367 races in 2019, ranking second in wins among North American harness trainers.

As a thoroughbred owner, from 2014 to 2019, Surick raced horses in 25 races at Gulfstream Park and Monmouth Park. He won seven of those races. He sent most of the horses he owned to Navarro and Tannuzzo.

Prosecutors say the defendants avoided detection by racing regulators because the PEDs they used were not detectable in post-race testing.

Last month, prominent trainer Jason Servis pleaded guilty to a felony crime and a misdemeanor crime. He admitted to shipping two banned substances.

Prosecutors had accused Servis of doping virtually all the horses in his stable, including champion Maximum Security, who was disqualified from first in the 2019 Kentucky Derby (Grade 1) for interference. Servis is scheduled to be sentenced May 18 and faces four years in prison.

## Surick sentencing marks end of chapter, but not the era of PEDs

With the sentencing of trainer Nick Surick on Thursday (Jan. 19), it concludes all the higher profile cases tied to the standardbred industry first announced in a series of indictments nearly three years ago.

For a second, I wanted to compare the end of this saga in harness racing to that of the steroid era in Major League Baseball throughout the 1990's. But the flaw in that comparison would have been that while there is still the sporadic use of performance enhancing drugs (PEDs) in baseball and other professional sports, you no longer have journeyman players launching 50 home runs in a season out of nowhere. Statistically, one can see when PED-use was most rampant. For the harness racing equivalent, it's far less clear.

The federal investigation asserted the distribution and use of customized PEDs between at least 2017 and its announcement of the indictments in March 2020. The operative words in that sentence are "at least," because performance enhancing actors at a widespread level long pre-date 2017. Every year prior to and since, there's obvious examples of miraculous turnarounds in performance, both in human and equine.

Coincidentally, in March 2017 I wrote **a column** that detailed Surick's success at the time. The column noted his .641 UTRS training percentage at Freehold, at which time he had 62 wins and 30 seconds through 131 starters. Around the same time, other now-convicted trainers such as Chris Oakes, Rene Allard, Richard Banca, and others were sporting similarly impossibly high training percentages across multiple tracks. In Banca, it brought a flashback to the infamous Devonshire Hanover race in 2006 when he took a \$20,000 claimer and bottomed out a field in 1:49 after setting fractions of :25.2, :51.2, and 1:19. Most of this is nothing particularly new.

What's maddening is that opposed to industry regulation, it took a privately led coordination to uncover the depths at which these individuals were using customized PEDs. Throughout the time covered in the investigation, some of the jurisdictions in question reported the issuance of fewer drug violations. What it speaks to is the inability for the industry to regulate itself. That, to at least some extent, is where the much-fought-against Horse Racing Integrity and Safety Act (HISA) was born.

With deserved remaining skepticism given all that has occurred over the past three years, transparency remains little.

It still remains easy to see improbable performances — even if there were no wrongdoing; and I'm not implying there was any in this case — that should at least warrant a public explanation because of a pattern they resemble. Towards the end of last year, for example, an 11-year-old gelding showed race lines for one trainer of 6th in 1:54.4,7th in 1:52.2,3rd in 1:52.4,7th in 1:53.2,7th in 1:53.2. Then, next out with a new trainer, was 1st by 6 lengths from post 10 in 1:50.3, easily taking a new lifetime mark. At least to me, it jumps out. Based on all that's transpired, there should be even more of a willingness from regulatory bodies to communicate to what one can attribute similar incredible improvements in performance.

The convictions of those individuals who admitted to or were proven to have cheated are certainly something to be celebrated. For the time being, they are removed from the sport.

But, it's not like any of these longstanding issues around PEDs end there.

This might have been the first time many of us have directly heard explicit terms such as "red acid" being administered to horses, but it would be naïve to think that the use of similar concoctions now suddenly ends just because the names of the people change.

And perhaps one of the biggest takeaways ends up being an acknowledgement that there will always be those participants that push the envelope. And with that, there needs to be a higher level of accountability. Still today on the weekly fines and suspensions (FAS) rulings, penalties such as suspension of a few days and a fine of a few hundred dollars seem comically

light compared to the types of prohibited substances found in horses' systems. Those types of light penalties actually do more to incentivize the boundaries of drug use more than deter it.

The goal shouldn't be to stop with only the most recent individuals found guilty of using PEDs, but to remain vigilant and work tirelessly to reduce the use of illegal drugs throughout the sport.

## Horsy Dream best in Prix de Belgique

The last B-race, Sunday's (Jan. 15) \$125,000 Prix de Belgique, resulted in two new names for the \$1,075,000 Prix d'Amérique to be raced at Vincennes on Jan. 29.

Pierre Belloche's **Horsy Dream** (Scipion du Goutier) was already qualified for the Prix d'Amérique after his victory in the \$215,000 Prix Tenor de Baune on Dec. 24 and in the hands of Eric Raffin, the 6-year-old showed that he will be a serious factor even when most of the top names in Europe contest next week's big event.

From fourth over, Horsy Dream quite easily sprinted to win in a mile rate of 1:58 over 1.7 miles while Decoloration claimed his spot in Prix d'Amérique as runner up. Philippe Allaire trained Hohneck was basically already in the Prix d'Amérique since his lifetime earnings are enough to qualify, but he finished third after some decisive work done by the judges in Paris.

#### Replay here.

In fact, Hirondelle Sibey finished quickly from far outside on Vincennes' home stretch and she was second to the winner Horsy Dream, but her gait was not satisfactory enough for the judges and she was disqualified.

Gu d'Heripre was seen in position outside of leader Beads and he could have secured a spot in the Prix d'Amérique after the disqualification of Hirondelle Sibey, but he too showed problems keeping his gait in the stretch and it was very close that he made a break shortly before the wire. Instead of grabbing the bronze medal, the judges disqualified Gu d'Heripre, so Hohneck, the horse who finished fifth in the race,, got his free ticket due to the mistakes of some of his opponents.

Horsy Dream and his crop brother Hooker Berry both showed that they are well prepared ahead of the Prix d'Amérique. Hooker Berry, who won the \$125,000 Prix du Bourbonnais in December, was fourth after the two disqualifications and he will be one of the hottest contenders in the big race next week.



# Legends Aiken and Butt give Group 1 Cups star power

A pair of Down Under legends have added a whole new layer to two upcoming major races in Victoria.

Former Kiwi Hall of Famer Anthony Butt and decorated Aussie horseman David Aiken – both well-known to many U.S. participants – have burst into the picture for Saturday night's (Jan. 21) Group 1 Ballarat Cup and the Group 1 Hunter Cup on Feb. 4.

And it's just what the races needed.

Let's start with Aiken because his story has a very strong U.S. link.

Aiken, one of Australia's most successful trainers, is good friends with wealthy New York owner Steve Finkelstein.

It's a friendship that started back in the early 1990s when Finkelstein sent one of his pacers, Ultra Jet, across to Australia for Aiken to train and it proved a resounding success.

Ultra Jet became one of Australia's top pacers of the time.

The son of Niatross banked almost \$A1 million with 139 starts netting 33 wins and 44 placings.

He came so close to winning Down Under's biggest race when second to Weona Warrior in the 1994 Inter Dominion final at the now defunct Harold Park track in Sydney.

"Steve and I became great mates through Ultra Jet and remain so today," Aiken said. "He's a great bloke and I catch-up with him every time I go back over to the US."

That endearing relationship saw Aiken buy a pacer called Leonides for Finkelstein a couple of years back and his success since moving to the U.S. has been terrific.

"We've been on the lookout for another horse since then," Aiken said. "I found one in NZ, told Steve about him a few weeks back and we snapped him up."

That pacer is the sparingly raced 6-year-old Cranbourne, who won 12 of his 44 runs in NZ for the White family before Aiken made the owners an offer they couldn't refuse.

It's a matter of time before he jets out to the U.S., but Aiken and Finkelstein could have some serious fun in Australia before then.

Cranbourne kick-started the new chapter of his career with a narrow but impressive win in last Saturday night's (Jan. 14) \$A75,000 Group 2 Shepparton Gold Cup where he beat recent Inter Dominion winner I Cast No Shadow and some other quality rivals.

It convinced Aiken to step him up again to tackle many of Down Under's best pacers in the Ballarat and Hunter Cups.

"That (Shepparton) win was the perfect start. He had a pretty easy run once he burned to the front early. It was really just an 800m sprint home and he's come through it well," Aiken said. "It showed me he's up to these horses and he should only be improved by the run.

"We don't have a standout horse over here at the moment, just a good even bunch, and I think he can be very competitive with the best of them. We'll go to Ballarat and the Hunter Cup, then he will go to Sydney and we'll try and get into the Miracle Mile (March 4)."

Aiken said Cranbourne is booked on a flight from Sydney to the U.S. on March 24.

"The timing is great. It gives us the chance to have a crack at these big races and maybe pinch one," he said.

But Aiken's excitement is broader.

"I wanted to find Steve a really nice horse, a potential top one, and I think we've got a really good one in Cranbourne," he said. "He's been really well looked after in New Zealand, not overly taxed. He's fast, but he's strong, too. I think I've got a pretty good idea of what sort of horse will be suited in the U.S. and Cranbourne ticks the boxes.

"His best is ahead of him and this racing against the good horses down here in the top races will only help develop him even more." One of Cranbourne's major rivals in the Ballarat and Hunter Cups, along with the Miracle Mile, will be reigning Victoria Cup winner Rock N Roll Doo.

But a freakish mishap will see trainer/driver Mick Stanley watching his stable star from the sidelines and in quite some discomfort.

Rock N Roll Doo choked down as the favourite in the Group 2 Bendigo on Jan. 7 and just as Stanley was easing him out of the race, a rival cannoned into Stanley's back, fracturing two vertebrae and sidelining him for a couple of months.

Enter Anthony Butt.

"Mick rang asking if I'd drive the horse while he was out. If you could pick one horse to drive in these big races, he'd be top of the list I think," Butt said.

While the Ballarat Cup is first, Butt's record in the Hunter Cup makes his engagement on Rock N Roll Doo such a great story.

Butt's seven wins in Australia's greatest staying races is a record by a driver.

But it's a decade since he last won the race driving Mah Sish.

"I reckon I'm due to win an eighth and this is the right horse," Butt said, laughing.

Butt is well known in the U.S. as the former driver of champion trotter Lyell Creek and he also drove former star Kiwi filly Under Cover Lover during part of her U.S. campaign in 1999.

Butt, now based in Victoria after a decorated career in New Zealand, first drove Rock N Roll Doo almost a year ago.

"Mick couldn't drive him a trial and I did, to get him back in the draw after he galloped in a race," Butt said.

"I then drove him in a Geelong trial last week, which he needed to do after what he did wrong at Bendigo the night Mick got hurt. The difference in the horse was amazing.

"We know he's strong because he's driven tough so often, but it was his speed which really impressed me. I drove him off the pace and when I said 'go' he picked-up really quickly and just put them away. He felt like a really, really nice horse. I can't wait to drive him at the races."

The Ballarat Cup shapes as the best open-class race run in Australia for a number of years because of the travel hassles associated with the pandemic.

Rock N Roll Doo and Cranbourne will be joined by Inter Dominion winner I Cast No Shadow and his exciting stablemate Major Meister.

Star New Zealand pair Copy That, winner of the past two Group 1 NZ Cups, and Old Town Road will be there, too.

And proven Group 1 performer Spirit Of St Louis may make the trip down from Team McCarthy's NSW base as well.

#### Here comes the judge

USHWA Amateur Driver of the Year Tony Beltrami spends his days dispensing justice as a Pennsylvania state trial judge.

For most drivers, the decisions they make in their job aren't life or death ones, but that's not the case for Tony Beltrami.

When the 2022 United States Harness Writers Association (USHWA) Amateur Driver of the Year isn't dispensing with his competition on the track, he's delivering justice as a Pennsylvania state trial judge.

"I'm the only amateur driver that's ever imposed the death penalty," said Beltrami. "That was during a murder trial where this guy was eventually convicted. He shot a responding police officer in the head in his home and he actually got the death penalty, which I had to impose."

Beltrami is a second-generation horseman who was introduced to the business by his dad, Louis, who used to take him and his three brothers to Pocono Downs as children.

"And sometimes on Saturdays, we'd go to the stable area at Pocono Downs and walk around and eventually someone would throw us on the jog cart in their lap," said Beltrami. "So, I've been around horses for a long time."

As a 13-year-old, he remembers being at The Meadowlands for opening night in September of 1976.

"I went to the races with my dad and my brothers," said Beltrami. "And the opening night at The Meadowlands, it was the most crowded place I'd ever seen at a track. It was insane. And I was also there the next year for the Meadowlands Pace, the first one. In fact, my dad had a horse racing in the first Meadowlands Pace. He had a horse called Mostly Cheer, Vernon Dancer trained and drove. There were two heats that night and I think he was fifth in the elimination, and then fourth in the final against Escort. So, I've always loved The Meadowlands."

Beltrami wanted to follow his dad into the business, but fate stepped in.

"I think I was 16 when I got my license and started working for Earl Beal in the summers," said Beltrami. "In 1986, I had worked up to be doing training miles with him. Then I decided to go to law school so I'd have something to fall back on, but I was going to go into harness racing.

"But I ended up like third in my class and I'm like, Eh, I should probably do the law and fall back on harness racing. So, I flipped it and got a job with a judge as a law clerk and then I opened my own law practice."

From law clerk to part-time public defender to part-time in the district attorney's office, harness racing remained a part of Beltrami's life as he owned horses on and off throughout that timespan.

"Then I ran for judge in 2003 and I lost. Then I reran in 2005 and I won for a 10-year term," said Beltrami. "And then, in 2015, I ran for retention [and won, which gave me another 10-year term]."

Beltrami presides in Pennsylvania's Northampton County Court of Common Pleas.

"Our court is so old it used to be a British court," said Beltrami. "And then after the Revolutionary War, it was converted to an American court. And in the big courtroom, we call it courtroom number one, are the portraits of all the past president judges of our court and they're all in their colonial garb. That's how old it is."

Beltrami was raised in Drums, PA, about 12 miles from Pocono Downs and currently resides in Bethlehem, about 30 minutes south of Wind Gap, PA.

"When Carmine Fusco opened Wingate Farm in Wind Gap, I think that was like 2013, he called me and said, 'Do you know where Wind Gap is?' And I said, 'Yeah, it's in the county I live in. Why?'" said Beltrami. "He said, 'I'm thinking of building a training center there.' And then he did and I started going up there whenever I could on a day off or in the summer and on weekends. And I would just jog and train. Then I decided to get my license to drive and started driving a year later. He helped me find horses to qualify and get my license."

From the time he got his license in 2014, Beltrami never had more than 18 starts in a year, until 2021, when he found the winner's circle 22 times with a win percentage of 21. In 2022, he equaled his outstanding win percentage from the previous year with a total of 36 trips to the winner's circle.

Beltrami credits trainers Fusco and his brothers, as well as Maria Alvarez and Williams Hernandez, with helping him get to where he is.

"If it wasn't for Williams and Maria, I don't think I would have been as successful because they started giving me drives before anybody else," said Beltrami. "I mean the Fuscos obviously did, too. The Fuscos really helped me get started, but Williams and Maria helped me move to the next level."

Beltrami's colors pay homage to his dad, who drove in something similar.

"My dad had horses with Mike Gagliardi and my dad got his "P" license at some point in his career," said Beltrami. "So, when it was time for him to make his first start, he just borrowed a set of Mike's colors. And he won a couple of races, so I had winner's circle pictures with my dad with those colors.

"I always liked those colors. And I took that color scheme but

I just changed the design. Unfortunately, he passed before I had my first win. He would have loved it. He passed in 2016, I started driving in 2014, but I didn't win my first race until 2017."

Beltrami follows in the footsteps of Tony Verruso, who won this award in 2021, making it two in a row for the GSY (Gural Settlemoir Yarock) Driving Club.

"We are very proud that two mainstay drivers in the GSY club have won this prestigious award in back-to-back years," said GSY president Dave Yarock. "As the song goes, 'If you can make it there, you can make it anywhere.' The Meadowlands is the world's showcase for amateur racing."

Beltrami, who also has a trainer's license, turned 60 in December and plans to continue to drive as often as his schedule allows.

"My term expires in 2025, so I'll probably stay until then and become a senior judge and just work when I want to," said Beltrami. "And then, probably train a couple of my own on the side."





# James Day is taking it day by day

James Day's best skill as a driver? The answer will likely surprise you.

The 26-year-old's response to the question came quickly, an honest self-assessment that speaks to the horseman's constant pursuit of excellence.

"I haven't been driving that long, so I don't think I have one particular thing that really stands out. I want to have that, but I suppose that will be a conversation for down the road."

Talk, for the time being, is a mix of how he came to be part of the standardbred scene, personal goals, a milestone victory, and his life away from the racetrack. Born in Virginia, Day had experience with riding horses before he was introduced to pacers and trotters through his wife, Hannah.

A welder by trade, when opportunities in that field began to wane during the pandemic, Day, after much deliberation, made the decision to pursue a career in racing.

It was a much different world than the welder had ever known. But he did see some similarities between the two roles.

"When I was welding, I was very competitive in what I did. I wanted my work to be the best and I didn't want to fail. Anything you do is competitive because you are constantly challenging yourself to be better. And that's what I have always done."

Two years ago, he started his own stable and earned his first training triumph in September 2021, upping that number to seven victories the following campaign.

Day posted a second in his first two official starts in the sulky in 2021 and recorded three seconds and five thirds from 57 races last year.

He opened 2023 in style.

On Jan. 1, at Northfield Park, Day and his seven-year-old pacer Mancino, breezed to a 4 1/4-length score in a time of 1:54.1.

Bred by Seelster Farms (Lucan, ON), the \$30,000 purchase at the 2017 London Select Yearling Sale is a son of Sunshine Beach—Ladycino.

"It couldn't get any better than that," said Day. "It was something else. But I can't really say I planned it out that way. I thought there was a shot we could win, and we were able to do it. He

raced really strong. When you're driving, that thrill of winning is what you are always chasing."

A trip to the winner's circle or not, Day never tires of the rush he gets from sitting behind a horse.

He reveled in the adrenaline rush the very first time he took to the racetrack.

"They are just amazing animals. They are so strong and athletic, and so full of talent. I was nervous the first few times I drove, but once you get more experience and more of that comfort level, you start to gain more confidence in yourself."

It's also exactly where he wants to be.

"I hope this is something I can do for the rest of my life. That's the goal. In the short term, I want to get better and keep pushing myself. You can always learn something new, things here and there that can help you, so I always keep an open mind when it comes to training and driving. I want to learn as much as I can."

As for his colors, Day called in a couple of experts to help him create a winning look.

He didn't have to go very far to get the sound advice.

"Both of my sons, one is five and the other is three, I asked them what they liked. My stable is red and black, but I gave them some ideas and that's what they came up with. They helped me with it and they liked it."

Day smiles at the thought of seeing those colors passed on to his sons one day.

"I put myself in a spot where hopefully one day they can carry it on. That would be nice. But for now, they love the horses. Who knows where that can take them?"

Unwinding from the hectic pace of the racing world centers on family life.

Day does his best to leave behind a tough day at the office the moment he walks through the front door. Not that it is always easy.

"We just enjoy hanging out together. I'm tough on myself, so if I feel I could have done something different to have a better result, it sticks with me. But I do my best to put that behind me when I come home. That's our time, no matter what happens. I just want to give my time to them."

He puts on his game face once he sets foot in the drivers' room.

"When I get there and I put on my colors, I definitely start thinking about the drives I have that night. I plan things out in my head, but most of the time it doesn't work. You go with an original gameplan, but you have to be ready to change that in a of person to push myself and to never be satisfied with what I did the day before. I would like to be a catch-driver. and you have to adapt. But that's a challenge I like."

It's what motivates Day each time he walks into the barn each morning.

"I think the majority of horse people would say that is what you want to achieve, to always move forward and do better than you did the previous season. When you win one, you want to win the next one. And if you don't, you just keep looking at ways to improve."

And, if you happen to be James Day, you remain committed to acquiring those difference-making driving skills.

For the time being, it's a work in progress.

If New Year's Day is any indication of where he's at, the horseman, who now calls Ohio home, might have something to talk about sooner rather than later.

"I've always been the type of person to push myself and to never be satisfied with what I did the day before. I would like to be a catch-driver. But to achieve that, you have to constantly up your game. That's what I'm going to do."

## McDuffee reflects on Bella Bellini's past and future

Wherever David McDuffee goes, people want to talk about Bella Bellini. Even with the number of successful horses McDuffee has had in the past, he considers the two-time Dan Patch Awardwinning trotter the most popular he's ever owned. The fact McDuffee bred her makes it all the more satisfying.

Over the past two years, the Nifty Norman-trained Bella Bellini has hit the board in 36 of 38 races, winning 20, and earned \$2.04 million. In December, she became the fourth female trotter this century to win a Dan Patch Award at ages 3 and 4, joining Atlanta, Ariana G, and Stroke Play.

Only nine female trotters in history have won Dan Patch trophies in three different years, and the question that might be on the minds of Bella Bellini's fans this winter is whether the 5-year-old mare will take aim at becoming the 10th.

The answer, McDuffee said, is not simple.

"I do want to race her, but unfortunately for trotting mares there aren't many races," McDuffee said. "That makes it more difficult. Obviously, she's a very valuable mare. It would be exciting to breed her and get some offspring; that's definitely on the table.

"But right now, I'm leaning toward trying to put together some kind of a program that makes sense. All horses only have so many races in them. I'm not sure how we're going to approach the year."

In 2022, there were eight Grand Circuit events for trotting mares older than 4: the Armbro Flight, Six Pack, Steele Memorial, Dayton Oaks, Allerage, Breeders Crown, TVG championship, and Miss Versatility Series. There were 12 Grand Circuit races for male trotters older than 4, and it is not uncommon for the top female trotters to take on the boys in those open stakes.

"There are some stakes races for the mares, but they are the same days as the opens," McDuffee said. "That eliminates half of the opportunities that you might have to race a horse (against the mares).

"I would like to see them consider creating more opportunities by maybe racing the opens on different dates than the races for the mares. It doesn't mean we would always go, but you would like to have the opportunity. I'm not afraid to go against the boys, but it's not something you want to do all the time. But they race for more money, and that's another factor."

Last year, Bella Bellini faced male rivals in three Grand Circuit races. She won the Hambletonian Maturity (restricted to 4-year-olds) and Caesars Trotting Classic and was third in the Cutler Memorial. She also faced the boys in two invitationals, finishing third in the Sebastian K and fifth in the Robert Miecuna.

Her other victories last season included the Breeders Crown Mare Trot, Steele Memorial, Six Pack, and TVG Series championship for female trotters. She also captured the Graduate Series final for 4-year-old mares.

For the year, she won nine of 19 starts, hit the board nine more times, and earned \$936,702. Her money total was the fifth highest in history for a trotting mare based solely on purses earned in North America.

"She had a great year," McDuffee said. "She had to race the boys probably more times than you would ideally like to do, but she was up to the task. It was an exciting year, for sure. I don't know if I could pick out one race and say it was better than the others. They say it all comes down to the Breeders Crown, and the Breeders Crown was a pretty special race."


Bella Bellini, a daughter of stallion Bar Hopping, became the first female trotter in eight years to win a Breeders Crown as a 3-year-old and transition to the older ranks and win the Mare Trot at age 4. The previous horse to accomplish the feat, Bee A Magician, was campaigned by an ownership group that included McDuffee.

In addition to her Breeders Crown win at age 3, Bella Bellini's other victories included the Hambletonian Oaks, Matron Stakes, and Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship. She earned \$1.11 million.

"She's put together an impressive resume the last two years," said McDuffee, who co-bred and raced Bella Bellini's mom, Bella Dolce, and raced her Dan Patch Award-winning grandmother, Pizza Dolce. "I'm proud of her. She's a neat horse. She wasn't particularly impressive as a 2-year-old. I probably wouldn't have kept her if I hadn't had so much success with the family. Somebody was looking out for me."

And now everyone is looking out for Bella Bellini, who at the moment is enjoying her offseason at Peninsula Farm in Kentucky.

"I don't know if I've ever been associated with a horse that's had as big a following as she has," said McDuffee, who was the sport's 2021 Owner of the Year. "I can't go anywhere without somebody asking me about Bella Bellini or telling me how they love to watch her race. I've had a lot of good horses in the past, but I've never had one like that. It's special."









# Bulldog Hanover voted Cam Fella Award winner

'The Bulldog' was standardbred racing's biggest story of the year, and no horse could match what Bulldog Hanover accomplished over the course of 2022. The Jack Darling-trained son of Shadow Play captured the hearts of harness racing fans across the continent, becoming the fastest standardbred in the sport's history when he stopped the clock in 1:45.4 in the William R. Haughton Memorial at The Meadowlands on July 16 for driver Dexter Dunn. During the season, Bulldog Hanover won 14 races in 16 starts with more than \$1.8 million in earnings for co-owners Jack Darling and Brad Grant, making him the richest Standardbred of 2022. Dexter Dunn and Jody Jamieson handled the driving duties, and his devoted caretaker was John Mallia.

Bulldog Hanover boasts an impressive resume of accomplishments including victories in the Dan Patch Stakes and Hoosier Pacing Derby at Hoosier Park, the Dayton Pacing Derby, the Canadian Pacing Derby, the Breeders Crown and the TVG Open Pace, just to name a few.

The racing community, racing fans, and casual spectators were in awe of Bulldog Hanover, who would draw crowds and media to wherever he raced. Woodbine Mohawk Park honoured the winner of the Canadian Pacing Derby and Breeders Crown by hosting a retirement ceremony for him in December.

Following the end of his phenomenal season, Bulldog Hanover was retired from racing and will soon start his second year at stud at Seelster Farms in Ontario, for partners Darling, Grant and Diamond Creek Farms.

In addition to the Cam Fella Award, Bulldog Hanover is a divisional finalist for an O'Brien Award, the unanimous choice for the Dan Patch Award and will also be honoured with the Stan Bergstein Proximity Award.

Standardbred Canada established the Cam Fella Award in 1997, and fittingly its namesake was the first recipient acknowledging Cam Fella's unparalleled contributions to the sport of harness racing. The most recent winner of the award was Anthony MacDonald in 2019. The complete list of winners is available here.

A national committee of 16 individuals representing the standardbred community vote by secret ballot to determine the Cam Fella Award winner. A winner must receive 75 per cent of the yes votes to win.

Canadian-owned, trained and driven, Cam Fella was an outstanding racehorse in the early 1980s, winning 56 races, over \$2 million in purse money and two consecutive Horse of the Year titles in North America. As a stallion, 'Cam' sired numerous world champions and horses with earnings in excess of \$107 million. In early 1997, Cam Fella was diagnosed with testicular cancer and was retired from breeding. He died in May of 2001 at the Kentucky Horse Park, where he had lived for several years and served as an outstanding ambassador of the standardbred breed.

The creation of the Cam Fella Award was the harness racing industry's way of ensuring that Cam's contribution to the sport is never forgotten.

# Plans for new harness racing track in Michigan

Representatives from Northville Downs in Michigan are looking to build a new harness racing facility a few miles from their current location according to a **story in Hometownlife.com**.

Although Northville Downs is scheduled to race from April through Sept. of 2023, the property they currently sit on was sold in 2018 for future redevelopment.

The new plan, known as Northville Downs at Plymouth Township, if approved, includes a half-mile track, two-story grandstand and horse barn among its features. Construction of a gaming facility, pending legislative approval, is proposed for the future.

Although nothing is on a docket yet, the Plymouth Township Planning Commission could have the proposal in front of them as soon as February.

Northville Downs, established in 1944, is the only harness track still in operation in the state of Michigan.

# Twenty stallions to stand in Virginia this year

The Virginia Harness Horse Association (VHHA), which introduced a new Sired Stakes program last year, announced that the number of stallions standing in the state for the 2023 breeding season has risen to 20, up from 12 in 2022. Two years ago, prior to the introduction of this initiative, just four stallions stood in the Commonwealth.

Among the 2023 class is first-time stallion Doctor Butch, winner of \$1.6 million in purse earnings. His career triumphs include wins in the New York Sire Stakes final at age 2 and in the Art Rooney Pace at age 3. The 13-year-old Art Major pacer is out of Classical Yankee by Jenna's Beach Boy. He will stand in Central Virginia at Stony Ridge Farm in Charlottesville along with Neptune (pacer) who is also new to the program. The Riverboat King pacer bankrolled \$324,044 and won eight different New York County Fair Stakes at the age of 2.

Also in the Central Virginia region is trotter Great George Two, who along with pacer Tom's Titan, will stand at Willow Hill Equestrian in Orange. The former won a Virginia Breeders Championship at Colonial Downs as a freshman and went on to earn \$426,684. His career best time of 1:52.1 came as a 3-year-old. The latter accumulated \$242,372 in earnings and a mark of 1:51. Trotter Climb Higher will stand in the same region as well. The son of Muscle Hill will be based at the Stoltzfus Farm in Dillwyn.

Six stallions will stand in the South Central part of the state, spread out among four farms. Trotter Dusty Winner, based at Charlie Dunavant's Woodhill Farm in Victoria, has sired 31 starters that have earned a combined \$1.8 million. Calgary Seelster (pacer) and Shibboleth Hanover (trotter) will stand at Dan Chansky's Double C/C Ranch in Keysville. The former won \$357,616 with a mark of 1:50.3 while the latter earned \$242,079 with key wins in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes at age 2 and in a consolation at age 3. Trotter Armed Dangerously, winner of the Fall Harvest Stakes at Yonkers as a freshman, will stand at Joe Coblentz's Farm in Nathalie along with another trotter, Secular, who was in the program last year. Lightly raced trotter Snow King, who has stood in Virginia for several years, has enrolled again at David Troyer's farm in Halifax.

Another six stallions will stand in the Southwest portion of Virginia including pacers Artzina and Jeneral Patton at Michael Viars' Farm in Pilgrim Knob. The former bankrolled \$780,063 during an impressive racing career and in stud, has sired 54 starters that have earned \$3.4 million. The latter bankrolled \$470,404 from 29 wins and stands his first season in 2023. Trotters Gregory Pecs and Crime Fighter will both stand at Gideon Brenneman's Farm in Tazewell. Gregory Pecs has sired 21 foals that have placed in the Virginia Breeder's Fund races while Crime Fighter earned \$185,211 in six years and took a mark of 1:55.1. Trotter Love Hunter, who also boasts a 1:55.1 best, will be based at the Cedar Bluff Farm in Jonesville. Finally, trotter Winning Fireworks will stand at Tracy Bradshaw's TNT Racing Stable in Bland. The son of Credit Winner, who won the International Stallion Stakes at age 2, has sired 48 starters that have earned a combined \$1.6 million.

Two stallions will stand in Northern Virginia at Equine Reproduction Services in Amisville. Pacer Well Of Fire is by Well Said and has a career mark of 1:51.2 while trotter Show Stopin Monkey won the Plesac Stakes elimination and final at the age of 2. He has a career best time of 1:55.1.

Virginia's Eastern Shore is represented this year too with a Muscles Yankee trotter out of Rosecroft Survivor. He will stand in Bloxum, which is near Chincoteague.

The Sired Stakes program will offer bonus payments for foals that meet qualifying times and dates as outlined in the rules at <a href="https://www.nha.net">whha.net</a>. Both the stallion owner and breeder will receive \$1,500, and if the mare and foal remain in Virginia for the entire foaling year, the mare owner will receive an additional \$1,500.

Sired Stake races will be run based on age, sex and gait as 2-and 3-year-olds. Elimination races will feature a \$6,000 purse and finals will go for \$60,000 (est.). Sired foals are also eligible to compete in the Breeder's Fund races during the same years, which feature \$8,000 elims and \$80,000 (est.) finals.

Horsemen are encouraged to book their mare's 2023 breeding to one of these 20 stallions. More details, contact information and pricing for each is available at **vhha.net** or by calling Debbie Warnick at 443-463-0917.

The Sired Stakes initiative will complement other VHHA incentive programs like Breeder's Fund Races and the Certified Residency program. An enhanced 2023 racing schedule at Shenandoah Downs will feature a pair of 7-week meets. The spring session will run from April 1 - May 14 and the fall meet, pending Virginia Racing Commission approval, will run from Sep. 16 – Oct. 29.

# Hoosier horsepower is booming

It's not just auto racing and paved tracks that are making investments in Indiana; another type of Hoosier horsepower is making a big impact as well. The horse racing industry is a big business for the state of Indiana, touching all 92 counties. The newly released results of a recent economic impact analysis, conducted by Purdue University, show the Indiana agri-business industry of horse racing has more than doubled in the past decade. The racing and breeding business linked to horse racing has now reached just under the \$2 billion mark of economic impact. The Indiana General Assembly laid the footprint for success nearly 30 years ago to grow the agri-business industry in Indiana by creating jobs, increasing goods and services sold in Indiana, and subsequently increasing tax revenues.

Purdue University's study was a joint effort between all entities associated with Indiana horse racing, including the standardbred, thoroughbred and quarter horse associations, Indiana Horse Racing Breed Development, and racetrack ownership. Like prior studies, detailed surveys were circulated by Purdue University, to those involved in racing, covering all aspects of the industry including breeding farms, training facilities, racetrack operations, and other impacted businesses in between.

"As a group, we identified there had been a significant increase in participation in our industry, but we didn't know the exact impact on the state," said John DeLong, president of the Indiana

Standardbred Association. "Seeing the results from this survey is very enlightening and encouraging to our organization which has worked hard to boost standardbred racing in the state. We are set to host the prestigious Breeders Crown for a third time in 2023, which only strengthens us as one of the most viable options in standardbred racing."

One of the most staggering statistics was the amount of investment within the state. The report noted between 2007 and 2020, a 59.2 per cent increase in horses owned, trained, or bred. Another statistic showed 25.1 per cent of the information reported resulted in an increase in Indiana owned property with an additional 47.9 per cent representing an increase in invested equipment directly related to horse racing.

"We have seen a lot of new farm development in recent years, especially around Horseshoe Indianapolis," said Joe Davis, president of the Indiana Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association. "This survey solidifies what we expected to see based on our growing numbers in racing and breeding operations. Plus, these facilities are directly impacting their local communities by hiring additional workforce, purchasing supplies, and bringing tax dollars to the state. We knew there had been a significant increase in our industry but had no idea it had amounted to \$2 billion."

Tom Mosley, president of the Indiana Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association added, "Our annual fall sale has shown significant increases over the past few years and the number of new owners is growing immensely. We are adding new stallions and brood mares to our program each year, which has elevated the quality of our breeding program. It's exciting to see this surge of interest in our business."

"We have seen a lot of investment in the Indiana Quarter Horse racing industry just in the past five years," added Paul Martin, president of the Quarter Horse Racing Association of Indiana. "The Quarter Horse breed is one of the most popular in the state through several disciplines, from pleasure riding to rodeo activities, including the popular barrel racing circuit. It's encouraging to see some of those people starting to branch out into the racing end of our breed. Our hosting of the Bank of America Challenge Championships this past fall, the industry's premiere event, boosted our awareness on a national level and increased interest in our program in Indiana.

The most recent study on the economic impact of Horse Racing in Indiana encompasses mature business levels since the implementation of casino gaming at the tracks, which includes the addition of table games at the two racetracks in 2020. The continued growth of the Indiana equine agribusiness that has been shown at each benchmark, in direct proportion, proves positive when looking towards the future and the implementation of further gaming opportunities.
