The claim game renaissance

High-level claimers are booming at The Meadowlands.

In the last few months, The Meadowlands has seen a resurgence in claiming races that once were a staple at the track and owners and trainers alike are happy to see it.

"I love it," said owner Brian Gordon. "I think it's been overdue there. The Meadowlands is the premier track in the country and for a while they kind of got away from that. You see across the river [at Yonkers] all the activity in the claiming box. There's no reason The Meadowlands shouldn't have that."

On Dec. 4 of last year, Gordon and his partner Matthew Morrison turned some heads when they made two high-priced claims.

The partnership took Save Me A Dance for \$125,000 and Komodo Beach for \$142,500. After taxes and fees, the final prices were \$133,750 and \$151,977, respectively.

Claiming races have allowances for age and sex, which increase the price tag.

"Those two horses were both allowance horses," said Gordon. "Generally, I think people sometimes get a little more aggressive where they put them in thinking it's the end of the year and people won't pay that extra amount with the allowance. We weren't afraid of that. I think there were two divisions of the [\$100,000 claimers] that night and we looked pretty heavily



at those horses.

"I know Komodo was going to be entered in the [Tattersalls Winter Mixed] sale [on Jan. 17], and I still believe if he was in the sale, he probably would have sold for more than the claiming price. I think buying him for \$150,000, we got a bargain."

Gordon and Morrison, who were the underbidders on Whichwaytothebeach at \$380,000 in this week's sale at the Meadowlands, have had offers to sell Save Me A Dance for a hefty profit.

"My phone was ringing off the hook after he won in 1:48.4 [his second start for them] at The Meadowlands on that cold night. He beat some pretty good horses. I don't anticipate either [Save Me A Dance or Komodo Beach] being back in a claimer."

Komodo Beach is now with Noel Daley while Travis Alexander has Save Me A Dance.

"It wasn't like they bought him for nothing, but they just figured he'd go for more [in the sale] and the way things went [on Monday] he probably would have," said Daley. "I think it was good that those guys stepped in and took those couple of high-priced ones. I'm pretty sure Burke didn't think he'd lose [Save Me A Dance] for \$125,000. No one had been claiming horses like that for a long time."

It's Daley's experience that people are currently willing to overpay for a horse that they want.

"I raced one in a [\$30,000] claimer, a horse that was just sent to me after Chicago closed [Monday] night at Yonkers and I got a message from someone just before the race: 'Would you sell that horse after the race?' I checked with the owners and they said 'No, they can just take him if they want to take him.' [Scott] Zeron drove the horse and he called me [Tuesday] morning and he never calls me. He said, 'That horse you raced in the [\$30,000] claimer, I wouldn't put him back in there.' He said 'He goes nice. He fits good there. He drives nice. I think you'd lose him for that and find him hard to replace.' And I said, fair enough and I put him in for [\$40,000]."

Komodo Beach is turned out and will probably not be back to race until May, while Save Me A Dance has been doing well and has already earned \$71,250 in four starts.



"When they approached me about claiming him for \$125,000, my thought was if he was in the January sale, he brings [\$250,000] or more," said Alexander. "And [Monday] proved it. [Claiming] gives you an option, if you're not scared to lose your horse, to race them and make high-end money. It's great. I have one in every class so it works out fantastic for me. I wish they'd fill that \$150 to \$200 [thousand] because I'd have one for that, too.

"I'm trying to build a high-end boutique type stable. Brett Pelling's my hero. To me he's the best. He's the GOAT, or one of them."

The Meadowlands' race secretary Scott Warren typically could fill claimers for \$7,500, \$10,000 and claiming handicaps from \$10,000-\$15,000 or \$12,500-\$15,000, but there was always a struggle for anything past that.

Warren was approached by trainer Ron Burke, who thought if Hoosier Park could fill races for higher priced horses, then The Meadowlands should be able to as well.

So, Warren wrote some high-level claimers in December that filled and even had multiple divisions.

"It exceeded my expectations in the beginning, but I'm not surprised they're still filling," said Warren. "If you go back and look at years ago at old, archived charts of The Meadowlands, you'd see all the claiming races that used to be at The Meadowlands. My dad lost a horse at The Meadowlands, his name was Greenwich. He raced him in the \$75,000-\$100,000. He was first the second week in for [\$75,000] and the following week we put him in for [\$85,000] and he was second and Peter Pan claimed him."

Gordon and his partner do a lot of homework before making a claim, including looking at a printout of the horse's entire racing history.

"We just don't go in blindly," said Gordon. "I've been claiming horses for 30 years and it's changed drastically with the purses. It's much more difficult and it's become a rent-a-horse game. Eighty per cent of the claiming game is like that because the purses are so high."

Like Gordon and Morrison, trainer Chubby Stallworth puts in the hours studying to find the right claimer and just took Monty Mono from trainer Carmen Auciello on Dec. 31 for \$22,000.

"I like the claiming game," said Stallworth. "I have people that want to claim horses. And the claimers are going for good money. If I have a guy that's got \$100,000, I'm going to claim five horses. I'd rather have five than one. That's how I look at it."

As soon as the sheet comes out on Tuesday, Stallworth's evaluating the claimers as is Gordon.

"I love The Meadowlands claiming," said Gordon. "I hope they keep doing it. I hope they write more of them. I would love if they had a [\$20,000, \$30,000, \$50,000, \$75,000 and a \$100,000]. I'd have one in each class. I think it would fill. I don't think they'd have an issue."

Adrenaline junkie Matt Krueger loving the responsibility that comes with driving horses

Whether it's coming from out of the clouds or falling from the sky, Matt Krueger always makes the most of any opportunity that comes his way.

It's been over nine years since he was laid off from his nearly 20-year job working at the Ford Motor Company in Kansas City, a life-altering situation that forced Krueger to find a new career.

After considering his options, he chose horsepower, but not the kind he had become accustomed to as an auto worker.

"My family has been in the horse racing business my whole life, so when I got laid off, I needed something to do. I went out and bought a set of colors and a race bike and went off to Balmoral Park. My grandfather [veteran horseman John Finn] had just passed away in 2011 and he was my idol, so I took on his colors. He had always been in the business and I watched his every move. When he passed away, I kind of got the bug and

then when the opportunity came along, I jumped at it."

Krueger's leap of faith has paid off handsomely.

Not that the journey to where he is now was an easy one. Far from it, in fact.

He laughs when recalling some of the early times in his racetrack life.


"It's kind of funny. I showed up at Balmoral with my colors and a bike, and basically, I just started begging for qualifying drives. It was tough. Homer Hochstetler needed a second trainer, so he hired me on. As a result of that, he started putting me on some of his horses. I did well with his stable – I ended up driving his entire stable that year – and you know how it is, when you sit behind good horses you win races. It took off like wildfire."


Krueger's first pari-mutuel win is certainly a unique story.

A combination of determination and dedication helped earn him his first trip to the winner's circle.

"I was sitting in the paddock judge's office at Balmoral and I had one drive that night. I was just sitting there in case someone booked off. A driver did call off that night and a trainer came into the office. The paddock judge asked him if he needed a driver. I was sitting there and said, 'I don't have one in that race.' So, the gentleman said, 'Sure, put him on the horse."

As he drove by the infield tote board in the post parade that night (Aug. 5, 2012), Krueger looked at the odds beside his horse's number.





He was caught off guard by what he saw.

"I kind of do a double-take and realize that I'm 1-5 with this horse, Katies Song Girl. The gentleman didn't know me from dirt. So, we're 1-5, we win the race and we go to the winner's circle. The announcer said, 'Congratulations to Matt Krueger on your first pari-mutuel win.' The trainer looks at me, his eyes bug out, and has this look that said, 'This is your first pari-mutuel win?' It was just circumstance and luck to fall into my first win."

That same year, Krueger's cousin, Lyle Scurlock, had a 3-year-old colt, LB's Allamericanjoy.

The driver and pacer hit it off immediately. Krueger piloted six of the gelding's seven victories on the season.

"He had some issues, but Lyle gave me a shot and it worked out really well. That horse gave me my first 1:50 mile and he opened up a lot of doors for me. I'm a firm believer that a driver is only as good as the horse they drive. If you're not sitting behind a good horse, you won't be a success. You can be the best driver, but if you're on a bad horse, you won't hit the board. And then, you're not on the radar. But when you get a good horse, that opens the door to opportunities with other trainers."

There have been a few bumps on the road since then, but Krueger has endured and posted solid numbers both as a driver and trainer.

Currently, he's in Florida, a place that he knows well.

"Last year was the first year I committed to Hoosier Park and it

was a pretty decent year for me. So, that's the plan. When they open in March, I'll had back when they start qualifying and start putting my name out there again. This is my sixth year coming to south Florida. The first four years, I'd come to race at Pompano, and that's where I met [trainer] Tony Alagna. He asked me what I was doing during the day because he needed a trainer. So, I started training babies for Tony. I did that for four years, and for the past two years, [trainer] Travis Alexander asked me to help him out, so I'm training his babies for him."

Krueger is also feeding his competitive nature during his time in the Sunshine State.

When he's not on the greens, he'll occasionally take to the blue skies.

"I've always been an adrenaline junkie. I started out racing motocross. I never felt pressure or intimidation, or a fear factor. I'm a very competitive person. I played sports all the way through school, so that competitiveness and drive is not something I had to learn. When I have time here in Florida, I play golf. I also like skydiving. It's the same with driving, that adrenaline rush. Someone is trusting me with their whole week's worth of work for two minutes. They put their livelihood into my hands. The rush I get from the responsibility that comes with that is amazing."

The feeling harness racing's thrill-seeker gets from jumping out of a plane is a mix of bliss and serenity.

"Well, the freefall is one thing, but when that parachute opens and you're floating 5,000 feet above the ground, it's just like everything stands still. It's so peaceful. Seeing the world from that point of view is amazing."

Which is exactly how Krueger feels when he's in the sulky.

Closing in on 400 career driving wins, the man who calls Manteno, IL home, has come a long way since he made the leap to harness racing.

He's not slowing down his pursuit of more racing success by any stretch.

"When I first started working with Tony, he asked me to come work with him New Jersey, and I did, which opened up a lot of doors for me. He used me to drive some really great horses. As a result, I started driving some Sires Stakes horses for him and then I went to Lexington for home. I've driven for a lot of great trainers as a result of that, people like Linda Toscano, Brian Brown and George Ducharme – when doors open like that, you want to make the best of it."

No doubt Krueger has done precisely that.

A fine tradition of sophomore pacing fillies that have been Horse of the Year

If Test Of Faith is named 2021 Horse Of The Year on Feb. 20 it will further a very fine tradition of sophomore pacing fillies who have been honored. Here's a closer look at that list-of course assuming that Test Of Faith gets the nod.

In 1981, Fan Hanover got the nod 133-20 over 4-year-old pacer Royce (Rambling Willie was fourth in the voting at age 11).

In 2001, Bunny Lake won and John Stark, Jr. became the last trainer/driver to have a pacer as HOY. Rainbow Blue won it over undefeated (12-for-12) trotting filly Syrinx Hanover.

In 2004, Rainbow Blue won 119-98 over Triple Crown winner Windsongs Legacy.

In 2021, Test Of Faith will become the second female by Art Major to be HOY, joining JK Shesalady in 2014.

All four pacing fillies on this list did or will race past their 3-year-old HOY seasons.

Irony department? Rainbow Blue's second biggest purse win came in the Fan Hanover (\$543,543) in 2004.

With only two defeats in 2021, Test Of Faith and the last two 3YOFP HOY winners have five losses combined. Rainbow Blue was 20-for-21 and Bunny Lake 19-for-21 during their award-winning years.

Flower girls?

Rainbow Blue started her award-winning 3-year-old season in 2004 winning each leg and the final of the Blossom series.

Bunny Lake lost her first two starts then ran the table winning the last 19 times. Those first two races? The Roses Red (Note: Not the Roses ARE Red)

Fan Hanover won the Fleur De Lys on July 10, 1981 at Blue Bonnets.

Pelling's place

Brett Pelling is familiar with top pacing fillies. He was the first ever to send out a sub-1:50 female — Armbro Romance on 6/27/98 in the Ladyship Stakes (1:49.4).

A couple years prior, Mystical Maddy also dominated for Pelling.

He will join George Teague (Rainbow Blue) and Glen Garnsey (Fan Hanover) as the only three trainers to have a 3YOYP and 3YOCP named HOY. Garnsey first had Abercrombie in 1978, Teague added Wiggle It Jiggleit in 2015 and Pelling had Rocknroll Hanover in 2005.

If Test Of Faith nails it down, Pelling will be second all-time on the in-between list at 16 years from first to second HOY.

Jimmy Takter holds the record from Moni Maker in 1999 and Always B Miki in 2016 - 17 years.

Pelling will be just the fifth trainer to win at least two HOY titles and not be in the Hall Of Fame, joining Nancy Takter (too young), Paige West (1960-1961 Adios Butler), Pat Crowe (1982-1983 Cam Fella) and Bill Robinson (1991 Precious Bunny 1994 Cams Card Shark).

Jujubee is 'by far the best' for long-time breeder/ owner Jon Erdner

Jon Erdner has been involved in harness racing for some four decades, and bred horses for nearly as long, but never enjoyed a year like he did in 2021 with Dan Patch Award-winning trotter Jujubee.

The homebred Jujubee entered last season as a lightly raced 3-year-old and blossomed into a star with victories that included the Breeders Crown, Kentucky Futurity, Phil Langley Memorial, and Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship. Along the way, he became the first 3-year-old male trotter in history to win with two sub-1:50 miles, capturing the Muscle Hill Trot in 1:49.4 at The Meadowlands and the Futurity in 1:49.3 at Lexington's Red Mile.

For the year, Jujubee won 14 of 18 races, finished worse than second only once, and earned \$948,791 to lead all male trotters in purses.

On Saturday (Jan. 22), Jujubee will be honored by the Keystone chapter of the U.S. Harness Writers Association as its 2021 Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Horse of the Year. On Feb. 20, he will receive the Dan Patch Award for best 3-year-old male trotter, as voted upon by USHWA's national membership. Trotter of the Year, as well as Pacer of the Year and Horse of the Year, will be announced that night.

"We're very excited and very proud of him," Erdner said. "We had a lot of fun last year. It makes it all worthwhile.

"We've bred a lot of horses through the years, and you never know how they're going to turn out. Some are better than others. This one happened to be the best. He is by far the best."

Erdner got his start in harness racing in western Pennsylvania.

"My brother was racing horses at The Meadows, and I sort of got interested that way," Erdner said. "It just continued. I really got into, and you know how it is, once you get into it, you want to win, you want to keep going.

"We did the breeding pretty much from the beginning. Our first mare was a Storm Damage mare. When my wife and I were first married, we had three foals every year on the farm where we lived. We did that for a while until the kids came along."

After taking a break from raising horses to raise children, the Erdners returned to the breeding side of the sport.

"We had some pretty well-bred mares and rather than quit with them and get rid of them, we thought we would breed some more," Erdner said. "That's what we did."

As an owner, Erdner's top horse prior to Jujubee was female trotter One Tough Lass, who won the Kentucky Filly Futurity in 2008.

"It was a 13-year dry spell in between until Jujubee came along," said Erdner, a retired investment advisor who several years ago sold his company, which at its peak managed nearly \$1.5 billion.

Jujubee, trained by Greg Wright Jr., is a son of stallion Creatine out of the mare La Cantera. Erdner named the horse with the name he uses when he can't remember a person's name.

"When I don't know, or can't think of a person's name right away, I'll say Jujubee," Erdner said with a laugh. "It's sort of a general name I had tucked away in my mind and thought I'd use it sometime. And I did."

Jujubee won two of five races and finished second twice at age 2.

"We took our time with him and got him ready to go toward the fall and raced him lightly," Erdner said. "He showed a lot of ability then. Then he really came on early in his 3-year-old year. He proved himself each time he raced, getting better each time. It was fun to watch him develop. Greg worked hard with him and kept him on schedule, did the right things, and it paid off."

Jujubee's 1:49.4 score in the Muscle Hill came on Hambletonian Day at The Meadowlands and introduced the trotter to the world.

"That was a real eye-opener, and he just continued from there," Erdner said. "He just doesn't want anybody to get past him. He has a heart that wants to win. Very few have it like that, too, so it sure is nice."

Jujubee was supplemented to both the Kentucky Futurity and Breeders Crown at a total cost of \$137,500. The colt had earned \$126,500 by winning the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship, so that money covered most of the expense.

"He earned it, so you might as well let him use it," Erdner said. "It gave him an opportunity to stretch his legs a little bit."

Jujubee will return to the races this year at age 4. He is in Florida preparing for his upcoming campaign.

"He's had a nice break in North Carolina and now he's back jogging," Erdner said. "He sort of likes the routine. We hope he comes back stronger than when he ended the year. I would love to see him break that 1:49 mark. He seems to be able to do what he puts his mind to. Normally, when they come back good, they get better at 4 and 5 and really hit their peak.

"We hope Jujubee is one of those."

Every day a thrill for DiCostanzo



As a teenager, Nicole DiCostanzo knew only one thing about harness racing — that she loved it. She had no family in the business but watched races constantly and eventually followed friends involved in the sport to the track. Before long, DiCostanzo bought her first horse, and there was no turning back.

Since making that initial purchase seven years ago, DiCostanzo's involvement in the sport has advanced from owning and caretaking to training and driving. The 23-year-old got her first win as a trainer in 2018 and notched her first victory as a driver earlier this month in a GSY Series amateur race at The Meadowlands. A second GSY Series triumph followed a week later at Freehold Raceway.

"I basically fell into the horse business," DiCostanzo said. "As a little kid, I was kind of obsessed about watching it on TV. I had a couple friends that were doing it, and I got hooked up going to the racetrack and started doing some paddocks. I didn't really know what I was doing, but within a month I bought my first horse.

"Ever since that day, I've grown accustomed to it. I've been doing it for seven years now and it's a thrill every morning going to the barn and jumping on a jog cart. I don't actually know what

I would do without harness racing."

DiCostanzo has a five-horse stable in central New Jersey. Last year, she won 15 of 122 races and \$257,264 as a trainer. Much of her success came at Yonkers Raceway, where she won 10 times and saw her pacer Uptown Funk compete in the open handicap.

As a driver, DiCostanzo got started in 2019. She raced 12 times prior to winning with Rockabilly Charm, trained by Victoria D'Alessandro, on Jan. 7 at The Meadowlands. Her second victory also came with Rockabilly Charm and the duo returns to the GSY Series for race seven tonight (Jan. 21) at the Big M.

"The biggest thrill I've had is winning at The Meadowlands," DiCostanzo said. "I always watched the amateurs, and a couple amateur girl drivers, and I was very intrigued by it. I wanted to do it, but I wasn't sure if I could do it. I did a bunch of qualifiers, and I wasn't really too confident.

"Last year, I put my head to it and told myself I can do this, and I want to do this. I worked very hard to get where I am today driving. It's crazy. I watch my replays and think, is that really me? It's a blessing."

DiCostanzo feels like she has clicked with Rockabilly Charm.

"(Victoria) asked me to drive Billy and he's been a saint ever since," DiCostanzo said. "She is almost convinced that he only goes good for me. I think I just get along with him well. I think he's a girl's horse for sure. He's got a great mouth on him, he's great to drive. He gives it his all, I'll tell you that."

DiCostanzo's favorite horse, though, remains her first, the still-active Steady Pulse.

"We've come a long way together," DiCostanzo said. "He's probably taught me just about everything I know."

As for her future, DiCostanzo hopes to continue her growth. Gradually.

"Last year was kind of the first year that people took notice," DiCostanzo said. "I'm just trying to succeed on my own. I don't really go over six horses because I do it by myself. I don't have any employees; I still pick stalls.

"So, I'm going to try to keep doing what I'm doing. I'm definitely going to claim a couple more horses on my own and I've got a lot of good owners right now. I'm going to try to stay between five to 10 horses training and then drive on the weekends for fun.

"My family and my friends are very proud of me. If you put your mind to it, you can do anything. That's the drive I have."

In addition to two GSY Series races tonight, the 15-race card at The Meadowlands includes a \$31,500 preferred trot. Warrior One is the 5-2 morning-line favorite.



Canadian Hall of Famer Bud Fritz dead at 86

Standardbred Canada has reported that Canadian Hall of Fame horseman William 'Bud' Fritz of Walkerton, ON died on Tuesday, Jan. 18 at the age of 86.

There was a time in the 1980s and early 1990s that the name of William "Bud" Fritz was synonymous with harness racing in Ontario. The Fritz stable came as close to dominating the province's sires stakes program as any single operation ever has. In 1949, the Walkerton, ON horseman began his driving career at Elmira Raceway. Since that time, he has captured driving titles at Hanover, Orangeville, Western Fair, Elmira and Owen Sound Raceways. His career statistics as a driver show that he won 1,982 races to go along with purse winnings of more than \$10.1 million.

Fritz has enjoyed some tremendous years as a trainer and driver, but none could compare with 1990 when Fritz trained a great pacer and a sensational trotter. Fritz trained and drove the 3-year-old pacing colt Apaches Fame to numerous victories that year. But without question, one of the most memorable achievements for Fritz came when he guided the hometown favourite to a stunning victory in the \$1 million North America Cup, Canada's richest harness race, before a near capacity crowd at Toronto's Greenwood Raceway.

Apaches Fame, who would later be inducted into Canada's Horse Racing Hall of Fame, would go on to win many more major events including the Burlington Stakes, the Confederation Cup and the Provincial Cup. The colt finished his season with \$1.1 million in earnings. That same year, Fritz trained and drove A Worthy Lad to a victory in the Canadian Trotting Classic, one of 30 straight wins that the son of Worthy Bowl would enjoy before being exported to Sweden. These two star performers earned national honours for their respective divisions and gave Fritz his third O'Brien Award title as Canada's Horseman of the Year in 1990 to go along with that honour in 1986 and 1989. Fritz also received an O'Brien in 1990 as Canada's Trainer of the Year.

Other noteworthy performers that emerged from the Fritz stable and contributed to his 1,068 victories and more than \$8.1 million in purse earnings included Silver Reign, Annie Ivy, Misty

Silver, Tommys Becky, Queens Arms, Silver Wraith and Halos Girl. Fritz was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in 2001.

In 2020, Hanover Raceway named its Rising Star Award after the respective horseman whose burgundy and white colours were a familiar sight at the track for more than 40 years.

Kaye Kessler, USHWA member for 66 years, dead at 97

Kaye Kessler, 97, a former reporter for the *Columbus Citizen* (later *Citizen-Journal*) who had the present longest membership in the United States Harness Writers Association at 66 years, died Dec. 9, 2021 in Littleton CO. Word of his passing comes within a week

of the report of the passing of Amos Finch, who with 64 years as an USHWAn was the present second longest-standing member.

Kessler, an Ohio State graduate, left an early job with the then *Columbus Citizen* to serve his country in Army intelligence in London during World War II. Upon returning home he rejoined the newspaper, was an active member of the Ohio Chapter of USHWA and served as an USHWA national director, but would achieve his major journalistic fame in another sport.

On a fateful day in 1950 he was assigned to interview the new head golf pro at the local Scioto Country Club. A picture was needed to complement the story, so a group of nearby golfing youngsters was gathered – including a 10-year-old named Jack Nicklaus. Kessler, who would chronicle the teenager's burgeoning career, later was regularly assigned to major golf tournaments when "The Golden Bear" started to become a golfing legend, and he became friends with Nicklaus while covering the sport. Kessler reported from 56 consecutive Masters tournaments, and his passing was reported on *Sports Illustrated's* website.


