Raffin and Bazire win the \$750,000 Prix de Cornulier with Joubma de Guez

The Prix d'Amérique is on tap this Sunday at Vincennes.

The best trotters racing under saddle met up in Sunday's (Jan. 19) \$750,000 Prix de Cornulier at Vincennes in Paris and the spectacular event ended with a great victory for trainer Nicolas Bazire and jockey Eric Raffin.

Raffin sat on **Joubma de Guez** (Carat Williams) and the leader Granvillaise Bleue was overtaken by Raffin and his Joubma de Guez with a little less than three-quarters-of-a-mile to go in the 2,700 meter race.

Joubma de Guez then raced in an even, high pace, a well-disposed ride from Raffin's part which made it difficult for the chasers in the home stretch of Vincennes.

Five mares ended up in the top of the prestigious race and this was the fifth consecutive win by a female trotter in the Prix de Cornulier.

Raffin claimed his fourth victory in Cornulier. His first came in 2003, on Joyau d'Amour and his next two wins were taken on Roxanne Griff, who won in 2014 and 2015.

For Bazire, this victory meant that the name Bazire would be written into the history books for the first time. His father Jean-Michel Bazire, long-standing dominant as a trainer/driver – and, some years ago, jockey – never succeeded in the Prix de Cornulier, so the Sunday win must have felt special for the family.

Joumba de Guez won in a mile rate of 1:56.2 over 1.6 miles.

TIME FOR THE BIG BATTLE IN PARIS

On Sunday (Jan. 26), the eyes of most of harness racing fans will be aimed at Paris, Vincennes, as the \$1,050,000 Prix d'Amérique is scheduled on a strong racing weekend where some of the very best horses in Europe will gather in several big races beside the big Grand Prix.

Since November, the older trotters from all over Europe have tried to secure their spots, respectively, for the big battle and after four B-races, the Criterium Continental and Prix Tenor de Baune, the field is now set and 18 trotters will chase fame and glory on Sunday.

Before the third B-race, this year's edition of the Prix d'Amérique seemed to be... let's say... quite profileless; a race without enough champions to reach the normal level of excitement.

But when Idao de Tillard and Go On Boy qualified for the PdA, the strength of the race increased and now we can look forward to an open event where the two named French

favorites will be mainly challenged by Sweden's San Moteur.

But let's not forget some of the outsiders. Hussard du Landret bested San Moteur in the first B-race and it feels like trainer Benoit Robin has been able to hit a condition peak for his horse this year. Hussard du Landret is one of the horses in the field that can do the hard work, race in front or take advantage of a high pace if he's not in front of the field.

Saturday's (Jan. 25) card is impressive as well. Some really interesting races are on the menu and even if the \$110,000 Prix du Luxembourg is far from being the race with the highest purse, the interest for the race is as always big. Conditions like 2,100 meters starting behind the gate for horses just below the level of the Prix d'Amérique contenders make the Prix du Luxembourg out to be a highlight on Saturday's race card.

But there are bigger shows to look forward to Saturday. The \$165,000 Prix Roquepine for 3-year-old fillies attracts 13 horses, where Bazire stable's Melba du Gers is the most merited so far.

In the \$325,000 Prix Ourasi, open for 4-year-old colts and mares, the battle will be between French-bred and Italian-bred horses. Italian duo Frank Gio and First Of Mind will be monitored by the bettors and when horses like Lovino Bello and Lombok Jiel defend the French colors, we can look forward to a race where action will happen.

Thierry Duvaldestin trained Mack de Blary seeks revenge on Golden Gio in the \$165,000 Prix Paul Viel for 3-year-old colts and earlier on the card, the 5-year-olds chase \$325,000 in the Prix Bold Eagle. It's a strong field that races over 2,700 meters and two of the contenders could have been in the Prix d'Amérique the next day.

Koctel du Dain and Kana de Beylev were both in the Prix d'Amérique by earnings, but they will race in the 5-year-old race on Saturday instead.

Unplanned returns of Karl and Captain Albano will be a rare win for fans

As last year's racing season concluded, with it came announcements that many of the best 3-year-old and older horses would be retired from racing and sent off to breeding duties. What became newsworthy was the sheer number – exceedingly higher than usual – of horses that would be leaving the racetrack; with it came the impact of what those departures would have on the older racing divisions.

It certainly was not planned, but as it turns out, both Hambletonian winner Karl and Dan Patch 3-year-old Pacing Colt of the Year, Captain Albano, will be returning to the races.

With both horses reportedly facing initial challenges that would impact their ability to breed widescale commercially, the bonus for race fans is being able to see the top horses race back at age 4. It is a throwback to how things used to be and is sure to enhance racing in the upcoming year.

Beginning with Karl, who has been an enigmatic type throughout his career, his addition to the older trotting group was desperately needed, and his impact as he races back could be profound. Nancy Takter who, in addition to training Karl also owns a share of him, said Karl is back in her barn and will start back training in February. She also noted that the star horse "looks amazing and has filled out beautifully."

Karl's return is welcomed as a fan for a couple of different reasons. First and foremost, the older trotting division will be one in desperate need of stars. Last year's older male trotter of the year, Winner's Bet, has been retired, as have impactful older trotters It's Academic and Southwind Tyrion who duelled at the top of the ranks in 2023 when It's Academic won older trotting horse of the year. In addition, last year's best 3-year-olds that include Dan Patch winner Sig Sauer, along with T C I, have also been sent off to stud. The division has been depleted so much that the exit of most top horses must have been a substantial factor in last November's hard-to-believe \$1.85 million sale price of Amazing Catch, sold at a time when it was assumed Karl was out of racing.

The other aspect in Karl's return is one of redemption and a chance to further bolster his legacy. Following a near flawless campaign at age 2, and even into his 3-year-old season, Karl's brilliance gave him the look of a rare generational talent. He delivered on the promise he showed in winning the Hambletonian, but as the sophomore season grinded on, Karl showed his mortality.

His retirement first announced after his Breeders Crown elimination where he was fortuitous to have made the final, he'll be looking at a 4-year-old campaign with a fresh, new outlook, and what a story it could be. If Karl comes back as I believe most would hope, it could set the stage for one of the more memorable 4-year-old campaigns. A Dan Patch winner at 2, he could return to the top in the upcoming year. It makes me ponder the question, has there ever been a harness horse that won divisional honors at 2 and 4, but not at 3? None come to mind, so that would be quite the achievement and a real

testament to his career, that wouldn't have been able to play out otherwise if not for his return.

Of course, if you wanted to look at it pessimistically you could say that Karl will be so dominant on return that it will actually make the division lopsided from a competitive standpoint. I don't think that will be the case, however. Waiting in the wings will be Periculum, and I'm giddy at the thought of a new rivalry between he and Karl. Periculum who will be a 6-year-old this year, successfully returned to North America last year after he had raced overseas in Europe as a 4-year-old and highlighted last year by winning the Maple Leaf Trot in 1:50.4 and was also second to Jiggy Jog S in the \$1 million Yonkers International Trot. Also returning will be a host of familiar foes from Karl's 3-year-old crop last year that includes Highland Kismet, Amazing Catch, Tony Adams S, Security Protected, and others. There's real excitement in this division now, which is unquestionably good for racing.

Many of the same points for Karl and the older trotting group hold true for Captain Albano and the older pacing division. Facing similar circumstances as Karl, being able to have last year's Little Brown Jug winner and division champion now return at 4 will provide a needed boost to the 4-year-old and up pacers. HRU has confirmed that Captain Albano has returned back to trainer Noel Daley, where the horse has already been training back for a few weeks.

Last year's older pacing group was certainly both solid and competitive, but one could argue that it lacked a dependable star week in and week out. After proving his versatility last year in winning on all sized tracks, including a 1:48.1 mark taken in his Breeders Crown elimination towards the end of the season, it'll be a true test of his ability to see how he adapts to some of the older, more seasoned pacers.

Who knows what the breeding future will look like for Captain Albano and Karl – perhaps racing successfully as they return to the races could lead to a road that involves both breeding and racing? But for an industry whose remaining fans are dying to have the best horses not be retired prematurely, the rightful return of these two champions will be something to look forward to in the upcoming year.

Gallo Blue Chip dies at 28

Gallo Blue Chip, the oldest living Horse of the Year (2000), is gone at the age of 28.

“He was the horse of a lifetime,” said trainer Mark Ford. “He’ll never know how many lives he changed, how many kids he put through college, how many careers he’s responsible for. I’m not sure why he landed with me. He’s the reason for this farm and so many things.”

The Magical Mike gelding was purchased by Martin Scharf after his very first start in 1999 for \$100,000 and went on to a \$4,260,959 all-time pacing record career. He moved into the No. 1 spot in 2001 and held it for 10 years until Foiled Again took over in the summer of 2011.

He was the 2000 Horse of the Year with a then single-season earnings mark of \$2,428,716 (bettered only by Somebeachsomewhere in 2008).

He won the Meadowlands Pace and the North America Cup in 2000 with a powerhouse season that included a 10 7-3-0 mark after his grueling Jug Day (second).

Bred by Dan Gernatt Farms, “Gallo” is the first horse to follow up a \$2 million season (2000, \$2,428,816) with a \$1 million year in 2001 (\$1,123,940).

That year of 2001 was highlighted by a win in the \$850,000 Canadian Pacing Derby and the \$300,000 Graduate. With a career chock-full of highlights, the 2000 Breeders Crown score in Canada by 7¾ lengths would certainly be one of them. (The other 10 Breeders Crowns that year were won by 12 combined lengths).

Another highlight would be the 2001 Canadian Pacing Derby, as irony would have it, it was the very same race a decade later, where Foiled Again assumed the top spot in earnings. Gallo ended Moni Maker’s two-year HOY reign in 2000 with a 156-40 vote. (187-14 over Western Ideal in the Pacer of the Year category).

It’s easy to forget that Gallo was undefeated at age 2 (eight-for-eight).

This year, 2025, marks the 25th anniversary of the Gallo Meadowlands Pace.

HOLLEY HAUGHTON TUFANO REMEMBERS HER BROTHER PETER HAUGHTON

It was 45 years ago, on Saturday (Jan. 25, 1980), that the harness racing world was rocked to its core when the news came that Peter Haughton was killed in an auto accident right outside The Meadowlands. At just 25, he was a bright shining light with a limitless future. He left behind his father, Bill, mother, Dorothy, and siblings Cammie, Tommy, Billy, Jr., and his only sister, Holley.

I caught up with Holley to help us understand what that time and that era was like for her and her family.

You were the only daughter/sister. Which brother was the most protective of you?

“Peter was the most protective, then Billy.”

Can you describe your relationship with Peter?

“My relationship with Peter was great. I’m pretty sure he was the favorite to each of us. He truly was very special, kind and caring.”

Did you see his horsemanship and desire early on?

“He always loved the horses from before I was born. Mom always said that if she couldn’t find Peter he was in the barn. One day after school he went out there and fell asleep on the horses’ hay.”

Is it true your mom was paddocking for him when he won his first race?

“Mom was on board all the way. Absolutely. Mom was totally on board with him following in dad’s footsteps. They made a great team and made her very proud.”

Note: Peter was 16 competing on the PASS circuit in 1971 when he won with Dr Dewars despite throwing a shoe with three-quarters-of-a-mile left. In his next start, Peter raced against his dad for the very first time winning while his dad was sixth.

Do you remember the outpouring of love/caring when we lost Peter?

“Absolutely incredible. But not surprising. Both dad and Peter had a way of touching people that they met far and near. Two extraordinary men taken way too early. It was one of the hardest things I ever experienced. I miss him so very much.”

What kind of statesman would Peter, born Sept. 22, 1954, have been today at 70 years old?

“He would have continued in the career he was in. He loved the horses, he loved the people, the traveling and everything involved. I know he would have had a beautiful family, probably a beautiful successful farm, and probably on many boards working to keep racing alive, prosperous and safe for all. Wouldn’t have been surprised if he had a son or sons following in his footsteps. What a tragic loss for many especially for us. He was a one-of-a-kind great young man.”

For those unfamiliar with Peter or even the name Haughton, “royalty” would best describe them. No name is more prevalent today in the stakes world than Haughton! Billy was the all-time winningest driver in wins and earnings when Peter started. Billy didn’t win the Hambletonian until he was 50, and then he won five in the next nine seasons, four as a driver. Peter got money in the Hambletonian at 21, 22, and 23; unprecedented. To this day Peter remains the youngest driver to win a Triple Crown race, when at 22, he captured the 1976 Kentucky Futurity with Quick Pay. Peter was also the youngest to win the Roosevelt International, twice, his last two times in it at 23 and 24, with Cold Comfort (1978) and Doublemint (1979).

“I miss him more than you can ever imagine,” Holley said. “He was such a very special guy. He treated all women as if each and every one of us was a queen. A gentleman of gentlemen. Absolutely the greatest brother a girl could ever have. I just didn’t get to see him too much.”

Dream delayed, not denied

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Remembrance Race takes place tonight.

For the eighth straight year, The Meadowlands will play host to a race in honor of civil rights pioneer Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

The race was on The Big M condition sheet for Friday (Jan. 17), but even with a plethora of horses in the box, it did not fill.

To their credit, The Meadowlands put the race back on the sheet for tonight (Jan. 24), and 10 horses dropped in, including one trained by reigning Dan Patch Amateur Driver of the Year, Yogi Sheridan.

"I didn't even check the condition sheet," Sheridan said. "I just said 'Just drop [Lindy The Brave] into a [\$10,000 claimer]: After last week, I didn't know they were still going with it. I didn't drop him in there for that reason, I just dropped him into a [\$10,000 claimer]."

"I put Tyler Miller up on him, and when [the entries] came out, it came out MLK with me on him. So, I said, 'Oh, okay.' So, I'm just hoping that he goes okay, because it seems like every time I'm in those races, I just never have luck."

Sheridan is one of five African-American drivers, along with Brandon Cruse, William Carter, Deshawn Sample, and Jim King Solomon, competing in tonight's fifth race, the Martin Luther King Remembrance Race. As The Meadowlands has done in previous years, the mile dash is a friendship race that also includes five Meadowlands regulars, Braxten Boyd, Bradley Chisholm, Justin Huckabone, Justin Irvine, and Tyler Miller.

In his celebrated "I Have A Dream" speech, Dr. King spoke of people not

being judged by the color of their skin, but by the content of their character, and how he dreamed that one day children of different races would join hands as brothers and sisters. It is that sense of unity that The Meadowlands celebrates with this friendship race in Dr. King’s name.

“It’s a good thing all the way around for the track, for us, for the principle of what Dr. King stood for, you know, everybody getting along,” Sheridan said. “You know, everybody coming together. I like the whole scene of it.”

Sheridan competes weekly in the Meadowlands Amateur Driving Club and finished 14th in the 2024 Meadowlands year-end driver leaders, so he understands the importance of getting to compete at “The Mecca” of harness racing.

“When I’m down in Virginia driving, everybody speaks of The Meadowlands,” Sheridan said. “They always ask me, they say, ‘Yo, how does it feel winning a race at The Meadowlands?’ just in a conversation. They say, ‘That long stretch, and all the people and this and that.’ And I look and I say, ‘Yeah, you know, it’s alright.’ And they say, ‘Man, I just want to win one there.’ So, that goes to show what that place means to racing.”

Prior to the MLK Remembrance Race not filling last weekend, Sheridan got calls from some trainers asking him if he would choose their horse if they dropped it in.

“I said, ‘Dude, you just gotta put the horse in, and whoever you get, you get, because I may not get your horse anyway,’” Sheridan said, adding with a laugh, “I said ‘You’re worried about me driving your horse? Guess what? There were nine other black drivers that beat the hell out of me for the last five years; beat the pants right off me. So, you’re going to get some good guys, I promise you.”

Since many of the drivers that have competed in previous editions of the Martin Luther King Race do not call The Meadowlands home and have traveled in from Delaware, Indiana, Ohio or Kentucky, Sheridan said it might help get horses if the field of drivers was finalized earlier.

“I mean, I know everybody’s got a lot of stuff to do, but if you get on the horn early and get the [drivers] who would like to participate in it, then you can advertise that these are the drivers for the Martin Luther King race,” Sheridan said. “So, then [trainers] see the 10 guys that are going to be there and they can look them up. Then when they look them up, they’ll say, ‘Oh, well, we don’t have problems putting horses in.”

Whatever the makeup of the race might be, Sheridan said the most important thing to him is that there is a race that honors Dr. King.

“It means a lot just because without him, we wouldn’t be where we are,” Sheridan said. “So, it means a lot to even have it every year. When I thought that we couldn’t have it this year, I was like, ‘Oh, man.’

“So, I mean, I’m happy that [Meadowlands president/chief executive officer] Mr. Gural and [chief operating officer/general manager] Jason [Settlemoir], let it go on for so long and let us compete.”

Down Under trotting sensation Just Believe calls it a career

For the past couple of years, we have been really spoiled Down Under.

The “Harry and Larry” show – that is Just Believe (Harry) and Leap To Fame (Larry) – excited and entertained like very few things before it.

But, as of last weekend, the twin-pronged show is over.

Just Believe, the trotter and elder statesman of the pair (Leap To Fame is a pacer), has run his last race.

The news came suddenly, but then again it sort of didn't.

Co-trainers Jess Tubbs and Greg Sugars (who also drove Just Believe) dropped the news of Just Believe's retirement through their Larajay Farm social media platforms at lunchtime last Saturday.

It ended weeks of rumors and speculation about the champion's future after a hugely successful New Zealand campaign was cut short by injury back in November.

Just days after he suffered his first defeat from six New Zealand starts last year – when a typically brave second in the Group 1 NZ trotting free-for-all after doing all work outside the leader on Nov. 15 – it was revealed Just Believe had a leg injury of some type. The exact nature is still not clear.

Tubbs and Sugars asked for time to assess and weigh everything up. They, and Just Believe, deserved that.

It was their call to make when they were ready.

Last Saturday was that time.

The beautifully crafted Larajay post read: “It's with a tinge of sadness, but an overwhelming sense of pride we announce the retirement of our champion, Just Believe.

“We could list the races he won, or the money he earned, but it was the hearts he captured around the world that really set Harry apart.

“His incredible strength and determination to win were second to none and we couldn’t be more grateful for the journey he has taken us on. A huge thank you to all of Harry’s owners for the opportunity they gave us with this incredible horse.

“In the end, it was Harry’s refusal to give up that brought about his retirement, with us no longer able to trust him to tell us when things were getting sore.

“He has nothing left to prove and his welfare is paramount. Happy retirement, Harry. We’re sure going to miss you.”

We, the passionate harness fans, will miss him almost as much. Just Believe raced 83 times for 38 wins, 23 placings and banked \$1,929,253 in prize money, which is second-only to the mighty Lyell Creek (\$2,256,724) as the all-time richest Australasian trotter.

It was a switch from former trainer Michael Hughes, who retired, to the Tubbs and Sugars stable in mid-2022 which sparked Just Believe’s stunning emergence.

In 42 starts for the stable, he won 30 times, with nine seconds and a third.

Just Believe’s only unplaced finish came when he struck trouble, galloped and finished tailed-out in a heat of the world’s biggest trotting race, Sweden’s Elitloppet in May, 2023.

The gelding won 10 Group 1 races, including two Inter Dominion finals, a Great Southern Star, Dominion Trot and Rowe Cup.

It was the trip to Sweden which propelled Just Believe to another level, on so many fronts.

It started with that gut-wrenching disappointment in a heat of Elitloppet.

The son of Orlando Vici had shown enough to that point of the race to earn some respect, certainly enough for the Swedes to want to see him race again.

And that he did for two fantastic races, for a third at Ostersund and then a remarkable second to the brilliant local Francesco Zet at Boden.

He won not only credibility, but also the hearts of the Swedes. They were desperate for him to stay longer; sure that he could win a “major” race over there.

But it was time to return home – for that same 60-hour trip he endured to get to Sweden.

At the time Sugars feared what toll the trip would take.

“It’s something we had to do and we’re so glad we did, but it’s a gamble for sure,” he said.

Instead, as good as he was before Sweden, Just Believe returned a better horse, much better. He was almost unbeatable.

“There’s no doubt he came back a better horse,” Sugars said. “He was different around home and better at the races. And he knew he was better.”

After Sweden, Just Believe raced 23 times for 20 wins and three seconds. And that’s as a late 7 and 8-year-old.

When a horse like Just Believe comes along, everyone has their own tag and ranking – star, champion, generational giant or all-time great.

Even the harshest judges would have to rank Just Believe at least a generational giant and one of the all-time greats.

Through Australia’s trotting history, the incomparable Maori’s Idol, who won 40 of 46 starts in the 1970s and regularly raced against and beat top-class pacers, stands alone as THE greatest.

Behind him, Just Believe deserves a spot on the podium with the mighty Lyell Creek – who spent a chunk of time racing with success in the U.S. – for second or third.

Perhaps the greatest credit to Harry’s impact came when news of his retirement made headlines in Australia, New Zealand, France, Sweden, the U.S. and no doubt other countries this writer didn’t see.

Thanks Harry, for delighting us with your greatness, endearing us with your courage and leaving us with so many wonderful memories.

And, finally, take a bow Tubbs and Sugars for superbly navigating him through such a complex and amazing two-and-a-half years.

Braiden Rhoades is on the road to success

All roads, it seems, lead to success for horseman Braiden Rhoades.

His harness racing journey, still in its early stages, has been prosperous both on and off the racetrack.

Rhoades, who hails from Garrettsville, located only 45 minutes away from most metropolitan areas in northeastern Ohio, was recently named as the 2024 Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association Terry Holton Youth Award winner.

The annual award is given to an Ohio horseperson between the ages of 13 and 19 who has actively participated in harness racing during 2024 as a driver, trainer, groom, breeder, race office/publicity assistant, track maintenance crew, or has provided outstanding service to harness racing.

They found an ideal recipient in Rhoades, who began his driving career in 2022, adding trainer to his repertoire one year later.

"I am very grateful to be recognized in this way," said the 19-year-old. "It means a lot, especially because I love racing so much."

It certainly shows.

After five driving starts in his rookie campaign — Rhoades posted four thirds — he won his first race in 2023, the victory coming with The Bus A, a bay son of Art Major—Rondel Franco N, on Nov. 14 of that year at Northfield Park.

His father, longtime Ohio horseman Bill Rhoades, was the trainer.

"Definitely something you will remember for a long, long time," said Braiden, of the 3¼-length score in 1:57. "To be able to do it with one of my dad's horses made it even more special."

Braiden, who posted 38 wins in his first year of training, developed into a bona fide dual threat in 2024.

He reached career-best marks across the board.

In the race bike, he went 42-48-52 from 443 starts, accompanied by \$466,313 in purse earnings. Braiden added 47 wins and \$465,789 in purse earnings on the training side.

Highlights were many on a dance card that included appearances across numerous racetracks in Ohio, as well as starts in Pennsylvania and Delaware.

One of the memorable moments came with Downbytheparade, a son of Downbytheseaside—Gracies Parade, trained and owned by Betty Clegg.

The bay gelding, bred in Ohio by Wayne Weaver, held court as the winningest 2-year-old in 2024, making 17 trips to the winner's circle.

“He is an amazing horse,” said Braiden, who sat behind Downbytheparade on three occasions, winning once and finishing second twice. “You appreciate those moments a lot and you hope you make the most of them.”

Braiden drove Downbytheparade to a runner-up finish at the Delaware (OH) County Fair on Little Brown Jug Day, Sept. 19.

“That was fun – all the people and the amazing atmosphere was just crazy,” he said. “Everything about it was so cool. It was one more thing that made 2024 such a fun year.”

What was the biggest takeaway from his 2024 campaign?

“I think it is that in order to be successful you need to keep raising the bar, keep pushing yourself, and to maintain a strong mentality every day,” Braiden said.

It’s a trifecta that continues to pay dividends for the rising star.

“I worked very hard, helping my dad, and trying to improve every aspect of what I do,” he said.

Braiden lauds his father for the impact he continues to have on his career.

“He has done everything for me,” the younger Rhoades said. “He has given me so many opportunities and been there with me every step of the way. Everything I have learned is from him.

“My dad once told me, ‘Keep a good attitude, keep your mind straight and you’ll be fine.’ And that’s what I do every day.”

It has been a winning formula, no doubt, for the former baseball and wrestling star who graduated from Ashland High School.

Braiden has also been the beneficiary of helpful advice dispensed by some of the sport’s most respected drivers who ply their trade at Northfield.

“I respect the fact that they are willing to help me when they don’t have to,” he said. “Every driver is out there to win, but for them to help me says a lot about their character and who they are.

“Ronnie [Wrenn, Jr.], Aaron [Merriman] and a lot of the other drivers at Northfield take the time to watch the races with

me and help me a lot. Nick [Clegg] is always there for me too. Whether it’s something I did right or something wrong, they give me a lot of great advice.”

Words that help further fuel Braiden’s commitment to achieving the career goals, present and future, that he has outlined.

“Long term, I want to be one of the top drivers,” he said. “This year, I am focusing on getting myself in good spots and giving every horse the trip they need to get the best result. Whether I am on a longshot or the favorite, I want to drive that horse to the best of my ability and bring out the best in them. I want to improve from last year and look to double my numbers.”

Braiden has also discovered that the road to victory doesn’t require him to always go the extra mile.

“Being patient within a race is something big,” he said. “I think that has helped me a lot. There were times, in the past, where I would like to race on the outside, but whether it was my dad, the other drivers, or learning it on my own, I realized that rail trips can be very effective.”

As for his best trait in the race bike, Braiden considered his response briefly before offering up his response.

“I think it’s being confident in myself and being confident in the horses I am driving,” he said.

Braiden, a fan of football and the NFL’s Pittsburgh Steelers, is grateful to have his father close at hand throughout his racing journey.

“My dad and I, in between races, we’ll go play cards or a game of some sort,” Braiden said. “Just being around him and having someone who understands racing inside and out is huge for me.

“I am excited about what lies ahead. It’s a sport that demands hard work and I am happy to put in that work. I love what I do.”

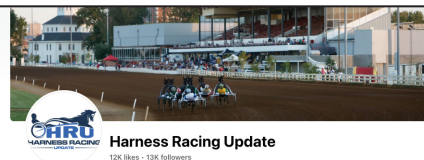

Big M to host race fit for a King

The \$10,000 claiming pace pays tribute to slain civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., who undoubtedly would have loved the fact that the mile dash in his honor is a mixed-race event that will feature five African-American drivers. The MLK Day holiday was Jan. 20, five days after what would have been King's 96th birthday.

King wanted a world where people of all races would get along, and one of many of his quotes that carried enormous impact was: "We must learn to live together as brothers or we will die together as fools."

The African-American quintet of Jim King Solomon, DeShawn Sample, Yogi Sheridan, William Carter and Brandon Cruse will take on Bradley Chisholm, Justin Irvine, Justin Huckabone, Tyler Miller and Braxten Boyd in the \$11,000 race that has been dubbed the "Martin Luther King Remembrance Race."

"All of us at The Meadowlands are so pleased to be having this event that recognizes one of the most important figures in American history," said Big M chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. The United States Trotting Association (USTA) annual meeting for District 7, Pennsylvania, was held on Saturday (Jan. 18) afternoon at the Omni Bedford Springs and Spa.
