Trittons plot path forward with Lochinvan Ant

After his successful U.S. debut, the Down Under pacer is plotting a course with Lauren Tritton at the reins.

If you didn't know anything and happened to look only at the tote board for last Saturday's (Feb. 4) winners over race at The Meadowlands, you'd never have guessed the greatness in that race. Evidently not thoroughly impressed by a steady stream of press in recent weeks, Australia's best horse from 2020, Lochinvar Art, was dismissed by the public at odds of 5-1 from just a six-horse field in that overnight race.

In fairness, Lochinvar Art had only raced sparingly since early in 2021, and there's been some water under the bridge since his greatest triumph, nearly to the date two years ago, when he won Australia's Hunter Cup. Still, it seemed backwards seeing heavy favoritism going to another newer, though far less heralded Down Under import, Burnham Boy. With Dexter Dunn driving Burnham Boy and Lauren Tritton driving Lochinvar Art, there's

no question that the driver factor contributed to the discrepancy in odds between the two horses. But it shouldn't have, as much as it did.

Though largely still unknown to these parts, the vast accolades for the 29-year-old Tritton are common knowledge in her native Australia and were documented here in HRU last year. And family commitments notwithstanding related to Lauren and her husband and trainer Shane relocating to the U.S. three years ago, Lauren plans to continue as Lochinvar Art's driver in their journey through the North American free-for-all ranks.

"I'm happy to stick with 'Arty' and I'm going to try to keep driving him for the time being," Tritton said. "The only reason I don't drive more often — and Shane would love to have me on all the horses as would I — is that I'm a mom and we don't have family over here, so it's very hard for us to navigate a caregiver for the children. You'll notice a lot of my drives occur during the day, which coincides obviously with school hours.

"The night meetings do become quite difficult for us and difficult for me to drive. But it's a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity getting a horse like Arty, and I've known him since he was a 2-year-old, so he's very special and I have a very special connection with the owners back home. In a worst-case scenario, if I can't make it — and I'll do my best to make it — then I'd have to look for another driver. But at this moment we're not."

Saturday's win with Lochinvar Art was Tritton's first lifetime win at The Meadowlands coming in her 21st start there. But driving on behalf of her Team Tritton barn in addition to picking up drives for other trainers in 2022, Tritton quietly put up rather impressive numbers last year. From 93 starts, a majority of which came at Monticello, Tritton won over a third of those. Between 32 wins, 13 seconds and 13 thirds, all told that was good for a UDRS rating of 0.468. That, while Tritton is still finding her way as a driver in North America.

"The racing style here is a lot different compared to home," Tritton said. "I'm still getting comfortable. And not comfortable as in I don't feel right out there; it's more of being comfortable with the way the races are run. Back home I feel there's a lot more tactics involved, there's a lot of bumper cars if you want to put it that way. We're allowed to push out, make a lot more

moves. Back home there's no holes, you don't give holes at all. What also is quite different is that we don't drive to the tote board, where here it's kind of post positions and the tote board that dictate where you put a horse.

"And I feel very comfortable from the male-female point of view. That doesn't bother me whatsoever and I've driven for and against a lot of these boys back home anyway. It's more the racing style and the way the races are run, not feeling like there's as many tactics involved."

True to form, Tritton was far more tactically active with Lochinvar Art than likely would have been the case with any other top catch driver. Despite making his first start since September, Tritton hustled Lochinvar Art away from the gate. After yielding to fellow Australian-bred Crunch Time, Tritton was once again on the move when she popped out from the pocket after the half-mile to engage and move past Crunch Time, before keeping her Australian champion together through the lane to secure a game win by a neck over a closing Burnham Boy.

Tritton noted that Lochinvar Art pulled up out of the race in excellent fashion. The immediate target had always

been the Borgata Pacing Series at Yonkers which begins later in March, but with Lochinvar Art coming out of his debut race so well, it seems likely that his next start could come in another week or two, at either Yonkers or again at The Meadowlands.

An accomplished driver on her own merits, it's still inescapable within this industry to not take notice of the dynamic with a female driving a horse of this potential caliber.

"I've had my first drive when I was 16-years-old, so I've been to the well and back with the boys versus girls thing," Tritton said. "It's been a war at times, you get beaten up. Like even after Arty's race the other night, the first comment I saw on social media was to the effect that if Arty wants to go to the top then I need to look for another driver. It'll always be around no matter how good I am; it'll always be someone beating you down and it's just how you get back up.

"I do wish that females in this sport here would have more of a 'we are good enough' attitude. Look, there are some bad



female [drivers] out there, but there's some bad guys too. The women have to get over the fact that they feel like they're not good enough and that they don't belong out there. I've had a lot of women contact me since I've been here, basically saying that 'I wish I could do that.' And I just reply, 'There's no reason that you can't.' I will say that for me, Shane has been my rock. If I didn't have Shane for those times when someone's beating you down or just nailing you about a drive, if it wasn't for him or having someone there like him to have the right things to say to build you back up then it would be quite difficult. So, I do wish females here would drive a lot more, but I know having that attitude can be hard. I've been lucky to have a very good support crew both here and at home."

Million-dollar babies

Slots filling for the fourth edition of Mohawk Million, but there is still a chance to buy in.

When "slots" are mentioned in the context of harness racing, it's usually the racino gaming machines that come to mind. A few years ago, the Mohawk Million set out to change that.

Bill McLinchey is the director of standardbred racing for Woodbine Entertainment. He is also the man in current dialogue with owners, trainers and breeders of young trotters, discussing Woodbine Mohawk Park's relatively-new \$1 million (CDN) signature event for 2-year-olds. The single-dash Mohawk Million features transferable entry slots for purchase, plus a 10th free slot for the colt, filly or gelding who captures one of Woodbine Mohawk Park's earlier Grand Circuit events for freshman trotters.

"This will be the fourth edition," McLinchey said. "There are nine slots available, and we felt it was important to try and boost up the [William] Wellwood [Memorial Stake] as well, so we offered a free slot to that winner."

The 2023 Mohawk Million is slated for the Saturday, Sept. 23 card.

"I think it's an important race on the calendar because it has a unique kind of tradition, a unique format," McLinchey said.

He likened it to the original concept for the thoroughbred Pegasus World Cup at Gulfstream Park. The inaugural running offered 12 slots at \$1 million apiece, with owners/trainers able to reserve their place in the gate before naming the specific horse that would start.

While the Pegasus later discontinued that format, it still had potential.

"When we were in the initial planning stages, it was the Hambletonian Society that gave us the idea for 2-year-old trotters, with the hopes of including European interests and not being locked into just North Americans," McLinchey said.

He added that the Pegasus-like flexibility of the Mohawk Million concept is an attraction for anyone who owns and/or trains multiple young trotters. Late-maturing 2-year-olds can replace others who have tailed off or not met early expectations. There are no restrictions on where they were sired or foaled and no special Lasix restrictions for 2-year-olds.

"That's what makes it unique: They have the slot, but they don't have to name the horse until the draw day, which is the week of the race," McLinchey said. "Anyone that purchases [a slot] at this time, I think, is feeling that they have a shot of having that colt or filly that's good enough, but if it works out that they don't, then they have the opportunity to make a deal with someone who does have that colt or filly that's good enough at that point."

In 2020 and every year since, all nine paid slots have been filled.

"It went well," McLinchey said. "It was different because it was new and it was a different format, so people were just kind of wrapping their heads around how it all worked. Fortunately for us at Mohawk, we have a great group of owners who did

step up and wanted to support the race, wanted to be part of a special event. We're always very appreciative of anyone who does step up, because I know it is a big ticket."

He said that both familiar names and lesser-known players have taken part: "Brad Grant was involved in the first three; Serge Godin (Determination), he was also involved in all three; Gino Toscani bought two slots in the second year and one slot last year."

Dan Patch 2-Year-Old Trotting Colt of the Year Venerate (4, 1:51.1m; \$936,735) captured the first Mohawk Million, racing in a slot purchased by Brad Grant, Marvin Katz and partners. The 2021 edition went to Dan Patch and O'Brien 2-Year-Old Trotting Filly of the Year Venerable (2,1:52.0m; \$1,187,798), for whom Grant made his slot available. Last year, the S R F Stable's Oh Well (2, 1:53.1m; \$740,380) won the Million, his slot was purchased by a breeder with a strong connection to the race.

"A unique piece last year was that Hunterton Farms bought a slot, because [Hunterton's Steve Stewart] had bred the winner of the first two editions," McLinchey said. "Hunterton, along with their partners, felt it was important to support the race and see that it carries on, so they purchased a slot, knowing that they don't race horses, but they would be making a deal with someone who did have a 2-year-old. Their slot was the winning slot last year. So that was really refreshing to have breeders involved and make the commitment to the race. We're very happy to have them."

With the Feb. 15 deadline approaching, there are still slots available for the 2023 Mohawk Million.

"We are not sold out yet," McLinchey said on Tuesday (Feb. 7). "The first three years, it's really come down to the final day. I fully expect that year four will be no different."

The price to play remains the same.

"It's \$100,000Canadian, and it's two installments: \$50,000is due February 15 and then the second installment of \$50,000is due June 1," McLinchey said.

McLinchey said Woodbine Mohawk Park was grateful to everyone who participated during the early years of the COVID-19 restrictions.

"The first two years, you really had to tip your cap to some of the non-Canadian [slot] purchasers, because they purchased and weren't even able to get across the border to see the race," McLinchey said. "It's been really refreshing to see the people that have supported it, and each year, there's always a new person who will step in and try it."

Gino Toscani has been one of the loyal supporters of the race and reached on Wednesday (Feb. 8) at Sunshine Meadows Equestrian Village in Delray Beach, FL, the owner/trainer/driver told HRU he was ready to help provide "whatever they need" to make the Mohawk Million an ongoing success.

"It's an exciting race and if you have trotters, it's really one of the best to race in," Toscani said. "They give everybody a chance... You can always sell [your slot] if you don't have a horse good enough to go into it. You can sell it to someone or make a deal for so much. The best part about it is you don't have to nominate a certain horse. If you have a stable of 25 horses, hopefully you have one that you can put in it. If you own quite a few, yes, I would recommend it."

Currently training 25 freshman trotters, plus another 15 2-year-old pacers, Toscani said that this early in the year, no one really knows which babies will rise to the million-dollar level by late September.

"It's too soon for that," Toscani said. "They're all going well, but that doesn't mean anything. If you have a number of trotters, it's nice to take a shot at it, see if you can race in it. The good part is everybody gets \$10,000back [for finishing sixth through last]. That helps a little bit too."

The Mount Hope, ON horseman acknowledged that there's a calculated gamble involved in buying slots. "Yes, and it would also be nice if we drew a little better, because one year I got the 10 hole and last year I got the nine hole [with fifth-place finisher What an Angel (2, 1:59.0s; \$62,655]," Toscani said. "It's risky, but the whole business is risky. Without owners, it wouldn't be able to go. Let's face it: We buy the race. It's an interesting night. We have to help support it, so that the big races like that keep going. It helps breeders; it helps everybody."

Otten catching big airtime on Fox

The Meadowlands ups its game with more shows on Fox in 2023

The Meadowlands is once again partnering with the New York Racing Association (NYRA) to present eight shows — two more than last year — to be shown on the Fox Sports networks as part of "America's Day at the Races."



"I think the shows have been very successful over the last couple of years," NYRA's senior director of TV broadcast operations, Eric Donovan said. "It's great to be able to be partners with the harness industry. So, we're just looking to expand upon that relationship and The Meadowlands has been a great partner from the start since we got into harness racing a little bit. And we're just looking to cover some more of their marquee events and just bring harness racing some national attention."

Jessica Otten, marketing coordinator and TV host for The Meadowlands and Fox Sports, is excited for the opportunity to once again share the sport that she loves so much with a mostly thoroughbred-centric audience.

"It was just cool to know that you were giving your insight, your thoughts and what you saw to a whole new world," Otten said. "For us to be able to tell the story of Somebeachsomewhere and Beach Glass and the emotion that was there, to me that was so freakin' cool.

"And then to have the world record broken [by Bulldog Hanover] on national TV was really great as well. Everybody, obviously, was not anticipating that like they were at the Red Mile, but we just knew what the horse was made of and we were just excited to showcase it."

Otten will mark her five-year anniversary as part of The Meadowlands team in November and it's not lost on her how far she's come in that short period of time.

"I was going to stick it out, but I wasn't sure what in the world I was going to do. I always used to be a person who needed to have a set plan every single day for months in advance and I've just come to learn that you can't do that. You have got to live life day by day."

Donovan had nothing but praise for Otten's work on the show, including her chemistry with his top-notch NYRA on-air team — Anthony Stabile, Acacia Clement, Laffit Pincay and Greg Wolf among others — but is also cognizant of the fact that she has taken on added responsibilities with the unexpected death of Meadowlands'TV host Dave Brower last October.

"Jessica does an outstanding job there," Donovan said. "She's balancing multiple positions, especially with Dave gone now, so we don't want to overload her too much, but she's always game for doing whatever."

At this point in her career, Otten is extremely appreciative of all the good fortune that has come her way both at The Meadowlands and from NYRA and Fox. And although she hasn't had the opportunity to make it out to Saratoga or Churchill Downs yet, she has been recognized at out-oftown harness facilities because of the Fox show.

"You don't know what opportunity is going to come about and when this opportunity came about it was great," Otten said. "I couldn't be more thankful for it. The people at NYRA have been so great to me. They are so great to work with. They've taught me a lot and they're so easy to communicate with.

"And, obviously, Jeff [Gural] and Jason [Settlemoir] are great for giving me the opportunity to be the person that's talking to thousands and thousands of people that have zero idea what harness racing is, or if they do know, they don't necessarily know how to wager, they don't know the terminology. So, it's like you are literally being the source of information for so many different people. And it's so cool to be trusted with that."

The first two of the slate of eight shows — Saturday, April 29 and Friday, May 19 — will again have The Meadowlands sharing the spotlight with Churchill Downs.

"I think it just works," Donovan said. "Churchill is a terrific product and The Meadowlands is outstanding harness racing and figuring that two of the best in the industry running at the same time, it made a natural fit to put them together and get the best of both breeds.

"We're committed to covering the best racing in both standardbred and thoroughbred, obviously, and try to focus on



some of the bigger nights, bigger days and high-level stakes races. That's something that resonates really well I think with the Fox viewers, so it's what we're pushing for."

Captain Ravishing making a name outside the harness racing bubble

Captain Ravishing could be a once-in-a-generation horse.

It's a heck of a tag to give the young pacing sensation, but the times he's been posting and margins he has been winning by speaks to something very special.

And he's raced just 13 times.

The son of Captaintreacherous is a bundle of speed and excitement.

Captain Ravishing has won nine of his 13 starts, but it's his seven-out-of-eight victories for champion trainers Emma Stewart and Clayton Tonkin which have set tongues wagging.

Those seven wins have been by a total margin of 133.4m: that's an average of more than 19m per win.

He paced in a career-best 1:50.9 mile rate for 1,720m winning the \$A100,000 4YO Bonanza while never seeing the pegs until moving to the lead down the back straight at Melton on Feb. 4.

But his greatest speed blitz came in his previous start, in the Group 1 Breeders Crown 3YO final at Melton on Nov. 19 last year.

Captain Ravishing again sat parked, this time over the longer 2,240m trip, and powered away to win by 28.8m.

His 1:51.1 mile rate for the longer trip obliterated the all-aged Melton track record and it came on a cold and wet night when the track was anything but lightning fast.

Australia's best known race caller, Dan Mielicki, admits being obsessed with Captain Ravishing. He called that Breeders Crown win and said: "Captain Ravishing, we salute you. You are a star.

"He's gonna be the most talked-about horse anywhere in Australasia."

Captain Ravishing is so captivating to watch in full flight, he's getting that crucial cut-through outside of the harness racing bubble.

Champion Australian jockey Blake Shinn tweeted after his latest win: "What a champion!"

While he is still a young star on the rise, Stewart and Tonkin don't even try to hide their huge opinion of the colt.

They won the feature race, the \$A500,000 Hunter Cup, at Melton last Saturday night (Feb. 4), but spent more time talking about Captain Ravishing's win in a support race earlier in the night.

"He's just a complete excitement machine," Tonkin said. "I wouldn't say I've trained a better horse. To see him come out first-up, sit parked and go 1:50.9 is something else. Horses don't do that. [Driver Mark Pitt] didn't even pull the plugs."

Stable driver Pitt, who has driven many of Tonkin and Stewart's stars headed by the injury-plagued but freakish Ride High (16 wins from 18 starts), is in awe of Captain Ravishing.

"It's hard to explain how awesome that felt," Pitt said. "When you say go, he just takes off. He is so explosively fast. It's a long time since I've had a feeling like that. I'd go back to Ride High.

"He did that easily tonight, too. He switched-off a bit at the finish, but if I'd given him a flick or pulled the plugs, there'd have been a lot more there."

Back to Tonkin, who was asked straight after stablemate Honolua Bay won the Hunter Cup whether he thought he or Captain Ravishing was the stable's best hope in the upcoming \$A1 million Miracle Mile at Menangle on March 4, without a moment of hesitation, said: "Captain Ravishing for sure."

It's that Miracle Mile when Captain Ravishing will be tried for the first time against Down Under's best open-class pacers.

Before then, he looks to take Australia's biggest 4-year-old race, the Group 1 Chariots Of Fire at Menangle on Saturday (Feb. 18).

Everything says Captain Ravishing will test the Down Under record mile time of 1:46.9 — set by My Field Marshal winning the 2018 Miracle Mile — if he's asked to in the Chariots Of Fire.

Do the math and it's logical, given he's gone 1:51.1 for 2240m around the tighter and slower 1000m Melton track. Now he'll go to the 1400m Menangle track, which is at least two seconds faster, and drops back to a mile.

Everyone will be watching the clock on Saturday (Feb. 18).

It's already clear how fast Captain Ravishing is and his next pair of mile assignments are right in his wheelhouse, but the majority of Down Under's biggest races are contested over staying distances, like the Inter Dominion and Hunter Cup.

And that's the unknown with Captain Ravishing.

His one defeat for Stewart and Tonkin over 2,760m in the Victoria Derby final on Oct. 8 was when he was simply outlasted by his very exciting contemporary Leap To Fame.

He tried to go toe-to-toe with Leap To Fame, who led with Captain Ravishing sitting parked, but was beaten rounding the home turn and finished 14.3m away in fifth.

It's hard to see how Leap To Fame could beat Captain Ravishing in a sprint race, but stretch to middle distance or staying tests and things become interesting. And that's why the world's richest harness race, the inaugural \$A2.1 million TAB Eureka looms as the most exciting race of the year at Menangle on Sep. 2.

It's very likely to be the next time Captain Ravishing and Leap To Fame clash.

And - and this is a big and - it's over 2300m at Menangle.



Travis Ellis' career takes flight after a short layover

It should really come as no surprise that Travis Ellis' horse racing career has taken flight.

He has been around horses most of his life, but the consideration of a full-time career in standardbred racing had never really crossed his mind, especially when he was dedicated to the pursuit of another job.

"My dad had a pretty good stable in Nova Scotia when I was younger, my mom had horses and my grandfather had horses, so I guess it's in my blood," Ellis said. "I had a couple of around five or six horses I owned when I was in Nova Scotia. I had a full-time job back then, and I ended up breaking my knee twice. I got kicked by one of my mares and was out about eight months. So, it was then when I realized I should look at doing something else, so I went back to school to become an airplane mechanic."

When the company he worked for recently went bankrupt, Ellis had to come up with a new game plan.

And that's when he recalled an old conversation that he had with a friend in the harness racing game.

"I still had one or two horses on the side, and then I ended up getting out of it for three years," Ellis said. "Two years ago, I bought into a horse in December, and he ended up getting claimed off us last spring. Once I lost my job, there was no reason I had to stay in Nova Scotia, so I got a hold of [standardbred horseman] Trevor Williams and asked if he was still looking for someone. He had been bugging me for about four or five years to come work for him in Manitoba, and it finally happened."

horses and I never thought I'd be doing the horse thing full-time, but here I am doing it. Last year, in Manitoba, we were winning five or six races a day. We had the numbers to do that. Ellis, who started training 14 years ago at Truro Raceway, where he amassed 369 starts along with 45 wins and \$48,900 in earnings, wasn't quite certain how things would pan out in Manitoba.

But the 31-year-old didn't have to wait long to find out.

Last July, he won the first race of the season at Miami Fair with Perpetual, a daughter of Vertical Horizon.

By the end of the card, Ellis had made five trips to the winner's circle on the 11-race card.

Not a bad debut, but the encores were even more impressive.

Jay Dees Scooter, a son of Youshouldseemenow, won the first leg of The Golden Boy Stakes. Ellis, who struck paydirt again in the Lady Crocus, winning both divisions of the event for Canadianowned or -bred 3-year-old pacing fillies, posted 17 wins in four race days at Miami Fair. He concluded the nine-day meet with 41 triumphs, with the highlight coming in the Futurity Final when Irish Melvin took all the spoils in the \$24,276 (CDN) race.

"We had around 15 or 17 horses and I never thought I'd be doing the horse thing full-time, but here I am doing it," Ellis said. "Last year, in Manitoba, we were winning five or six races a day. We had the numbers to do that. We did well in the stakes races out there too. I wouldn't say there was any particular highlight. I think we just had a solid year all around."

After making a name for himself at Miami Fair, Ellis trekked further west to compete at Century Downs in Calgary.

It was there where he earned win No. 50 on the campaign when Mystic Dragon took the first race on the Oct. 14 card.

By season's end, Ellis posted 60 wins, 132 top-three finishes, \$231,692 in earnings and a .358 UTRS.

Currently, Ellis and his band of 26 trainees are in Cal-Expo.

"I can't take all the credit," Ellis said. "I've had great support along the way, at every stop on my career, including the people here with me in California. I have 26 horses with me here. The owners are happy and as long as we keep working hard and having success, it's all good."

A slow start to the Cal-Expo meet is now out of sight and out of mind.

"It's been pretty good," Ellis said. "It was slow for about a month, month and a half, with no racing for a few weeks because of the rain and our horses weren't faring that well. But the weather is better and the horses are starting to come around. Towards the end of 2022, we sort of tailed off a bit, but we hadn't shipped down here and when we did get here, the weather wasn't cooperating, and I didn't click as I thought we should have.

"It took some time to adjust to the new feed program — you can't get the same stuff here that you get back home — and make sure the horses were getting what they need to excel. Since we got that figured out, the first part of the year has been on-point.



We're racing 10-12 a night, so for the most part, everything seems to be firing the way we hoped it would."

Impressive on all fronts, even more so considering Ellis hadn't envisioned himself being in such a position.

"I figured I'd just be out in Manitoba for a bit and then go back and figure out the airplane stuff again, but Trevor convinced me to go to Alberta and train for him," Ellis said. "I went there for eight weeks and raced just over a dozen horses. We had a pretty good run there and that led us to California."

The hundreds of miles spent in the air and on the roads is time well spent for Ellis, who recently won a pair of stakes at the Sacramento oval, the Alan Horowitz with Flying Officer and the Jack Williams with HF Flower, both on Jan. 22.

Being all over the map, literally, through his racing life, is a welcome opportunity.

"I like to travel," Ellis said. "When I was working in the airplane industry, I was going to Puerto Rico, Texas, and other places. It was a Canadian-based company, but I got to travel a lot. So, it was work and fun, and there's no sense working if you can't have fun. You go from fixing planes to working with horses. I guess it is kind of a different jump. I let the aircraft go to the wayside, but I still have time to decide if I want to go back to it."

For now, Ellis is content to see how it all plays out.

After Cal-Expo, he'll head to Running Aces in Minnesota, another chance and another venue to chase success.

"After Cali, we're taking some to Running Aces and others are going back to Manitoba," Ellis said. "That's where the Williams are, so they will be happy to see their horses and eventually race there. Wherever I go, I try to make friends and fit in. I talk to everyone and as long as you can keep people as a friend and not an enemy, it's all good."

Horsepower, for the time being, has usurped air power.

And Ellis is fine with that, hard work and all.

"Life is good," Ellis said. "When I'm not at the track or the barn, I just like hanging out with my friends, have a few beers and enjoy yourself. You don't get much time away from the horses. My girlfriend and I went home for Christmas for about six or seven days, but you never shut your brain off when you're away from the horses. You're wondering how things are going. It is not a 9-5 job, but that goes for any horse person. If it doesn't feel like work, it's more of a hobby. That's how it feels for me."

MAHARAJAH AND READY CASH TOPS AMONG EUROPE'S SIRES

Maharajah continues to dominate the sire ranks in Sweden, Finland and The Netherlands. The Viking Kronos son claimed his third-consecutive title in his native country in outstanding style in 2022.

Ready Cash was the runner up in Sweden and the French top sire held on to another win in his home country, even if he had his worst year as a sire since his first champion title.

Ready Cash's biggest wins as a sire in 2022 came from Flamme du Goutier's triumph in the \$725,000 Prix de Cornulier; Ideal du Pommeau's victory in the \$415,000 European Derby and Italiano Ver's win in the \$315,000 Criterium des 4 ans.

Moni Viking was Maharajah's best offspring last season. He claimed two Group 1 races and collected some \$270,000 for his bank account. Maharajah's vast crops, particularly in Sweden, makes him hard to push off the throne and we will probably see him in the top spot when 2023 sums up.

However, Ready Cash will face increasingly tougher competition in France and how the list looks in that country next year is a little more unpredictable.



Record purse expected for 78th Little Brown Jug

Plainridge Park's \$3.27 million stakes slate is richest in state history

The continuously improving harness racing program in Massachusetts will hit another milestone this year after Plainridge Park management announced they will add two new stakes to the already stellar schedule.

The added purse from those events will push the total estimated value of the 2023 stakes to \$3.27 million, making it the most lucrative offering of stakes prizes in the history of harness racing in New England.

Plainridge Park kicks off its live racing season on Monday (April 10) and the stake action begins only three weeks later.

First up is the \$100,000 (est.) Paul Revere Open Pace for 3-year-olds which will be held on Thursday (May 4) and is the first major test of the year for sophomore pacers. Nominations along with \$300 are due Wednesday (Feb. 15) with a \$300 sustaining payment due on Wednesday (March 15). A \$200 starting fee is due upon declaration.

Next is the \$100,000 (est.) Battle Of Bunker Hill Open Trot on Monday (May 15) for 3-year-old trotting colts. Nominations along with \$300 are due Wednesday (Feb. 15) with a \$300 sustaining payment due on Wednesday (March 15). A \$200 starting fee is due upon declaration.

Then on Sunday (July 23), it's the biggest day of the summer with the renewal of the \$250,000 Spirit Of Massachusetts Trot and \$100,000 Clara Barton Distaff Pace.

Nominations for the Spirit Of Massachusetts along with \$1,000 are due Wednesday (Feb. 15) with a \$1,500 sustaining payment due on Wednesday (March 15). A \$2,500 starting fee is due upon declaration and there is an option for a supplemental entry with a \$20,000 declaration fee.

This year's Clara Barton nominations along with \$500 are due Wednesday (Feb. 15) with a \$1,000 sustaining payment due on Wednesday (March 15). A \$1,500 starting fee is due upon declaration and there is an option for a supplemental entry with a \$7,500 declaration fee and \$1,500 entry fee.

The \$2.56 million (est.) Massachusetts Sire Stakes will reconvene in September and follow the same format of three preliminary legs and a final.

The two new stakes on the Plainridge Park calendar this year will make their debut on Monday (Oct. 9), which is the off-week for the Massachusetts Sire Stakes.

The \$40,000 (est.) Reynolds Stake is for 3-year-old pacers and will be contested by gender. "The Tar Heel" is the colt and gelding division and "The Leta Long" is for fillies. Nominations for both the Tar Heel and Leta Long along with \$300 are due Wednesday (Feb. 15) with a \$300 sustaining payment due on Wednesday (March 15). A \$500 starting fee is due upon declaration.

The \$40,000 (est.) Colonial Trot for 3-year-old trotters is the companion stake to the Reynolds and will also be contested by gender with the filly division going as the Colonial Oaks. Nominations along with \$300 are due Wednesday (Feb. 15) with a \$300 sustaining payment due on Wednesday (March 15). A \$200 starting fee is due upon declaration.

The 2023 Plainridge Park meet runs for 108 days through Thursday (Nov. 30).

Maryland racing trending in right direction

The early-season numbers at Rosecroft Raceway have been encouraging, according to information gathered at the Feb. 7 Maryland Racing Commission (MRC) meeting, conducted at Laurel Park.

Mike Rogers, acting president of the Maryland Jockey Club, which owns Rosecroft, said pari-mutuel handle on the Maryland product — currently Rosecroft and Laurel Park, which began its Thoroughbred winter meet Jan. 1 — "seems to be trending in the right direction."

He said total handle on live racing at Rosecroft is up 122 percent year over year.

Rosecroft began its 2023 winter-spring meet in mid-January, racing Tuesday and Thursday evenings each week. Lisa Watts, director of operations at Rosecroft, said total handle has been in excess of \$400,000 per night with the exception of one program.

Also at the MRC meeting, Jackie MacLeod, president of the Maryland Horse Breeders Association, presented MRC members with its 2023 stallion directory and noted that in 2022, eight divisional Maryland Sires Stakes speed records were broken or tied at Rosecroft and Ocean Downs Casino.

"It has been an exceptional year for the sire stakes program," said MacLeod.

Ocean Downs was approved for \$157,000 in racing-related capital improvement expenditures through the Racetrack Facilities Renewal Account, which is funded by 1 per cent of casino video lottery terminal revenue. In addition, Ocean Downs general manager Bobbi Sample told the commission the track is working on a contract with the Cloverleaf Standardbred Owners' Association for 2023 and does not expect issues in reaching an agreement.

Ocean Downs begins its meet Memorial Day, May 29, about two weeks after the Rosecroft meet concludes.
