Adrienne Hall: “I did not in any way have to testify... I was voluntarily helping them”

Trainer at the centre of a controversy at The Meadowlands – after testifying against Dr. Seth Fishman and admitting to using performance enhancing drugs supplied by the vet – gives her side of the story

Early in the morning on Feb. 3, a press release was sent out by The Meadowlands stating that the Feb. 5 card would include two horses owned by Adrienne Hall.

Following that release, social media blew up like an atomic bomb.

Many were mystified by The Meadowlands' president and chief executive officer Jeff Gural, a known proponent of ridding the sport of drugs, allowing Hall to race.

Hall, 42, had testified on Thursday, Jan. 27 ([full story here](#)), against Dr. Seth Fishman, a veterinarian convicted on two counts of drug adulteration and misbranding, with intent to defraud and mislead ([full story here](#)). In her testimony, Hall admitted to administering possible performance enhancing drugs (PED) to her two horses.

On Feb. 1, the United States Trotting Association (USTA) rescinded Hall's membership.

In his press release ([full story here](#)), Gural said in part, “We disagree with the USTA decision and we applaud Ms. Hall for coming forward.

“To penalize those who testify for the prosecution will only serve to further the already existing notion that “saying something will only lead to problems for yourself.” It will discourage the type of participation necessary to convict the indicted persons, as Ms. Hall's testimony has helped on this case.”

In social media posts, some were saying that Hall only testified

because she was going to be arrested or was being threatened that she was going to be indicted, neither of which is accurate.

Hall tried to set the record straight in a post on Facebook, but many seemed more interested in bashing than understanding.

Hall said she still clearly remembers the day she was contacted by the government about Fishman. She felt she had nothing to hide and, indeed, since they had wiretaps, there wasn't anything she could hide.

"I did not in any way have to testify," said Hall. "I was never subpoenaed. I was never forced or threatened. I was voluntarily helping them because I knew the stuff that was said on those tapes were very damaging to Fishman."

"He said things on our calls that he did not say to anyone else. I understood that and I wanted to help. They made it clear that they were doing this to clean up the business and it would make it better for the horses and I said yeah, I'll help you guys."

Even though her connection to Fishman ended when she moved to New Jersey from Florida in 2019, she spoke with him often in the previous five months because he was recommended to her as a highly respected, top-notch vet. And being new to the business, she was constantly looking to talk and learn.

"Anyone that knows me from back then, probably were so annoyed by me, because I would ask so many questions of everyone, blacksmiths, other trainers," said Hall. "Coming into this, I was always on the business side of it and I was just learning as I went and it was stupid to do it that way. But I asked so many questions and only wanted to talk about my horses and just wanted to learn everything as fast as I could. So yes, I really

respected his opinion."

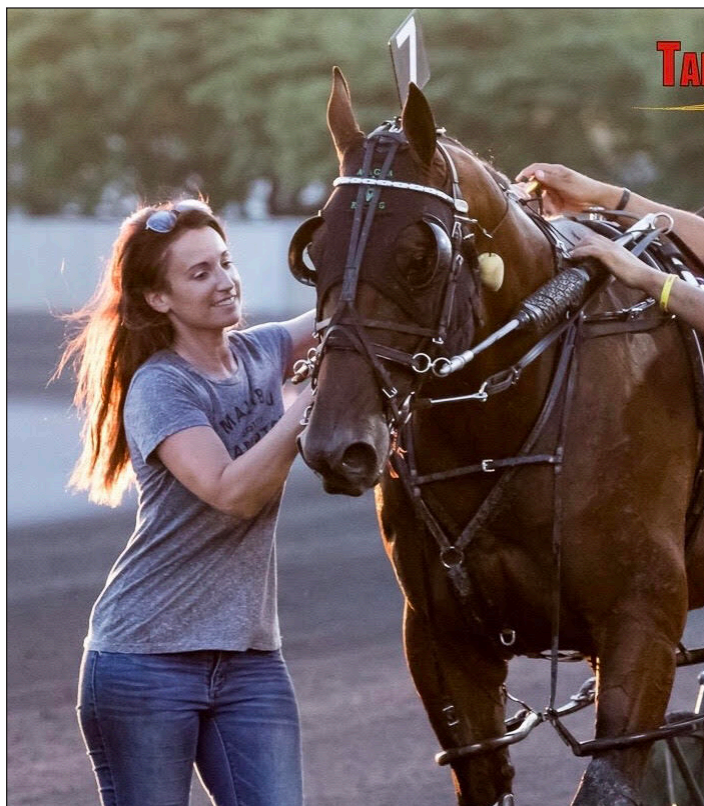
Hall had two horses at the time and often sent Fishman their bloodwork and was interested if there was anything she should be doing to make them more competitive.

"I really appreciated being able to turn to someone as knowledgeable as him," said Hall. "I thought he was brilliant. I thought he was so smart. I would send him my bloodwork. I would go over the problems I was having and we did a lot of talking about the horses."

"He never actually saw them, though, which is a big problem I guess because vets aren't supposed to be diagnosing and giving medication without being there and physically examining the horse first."

Fishman gave her some free samples that weren't properly labeled and some that were just color coded and told her that it would help her horses but not hurt them.

"The whole thing made me uncomfortable," said Hall. "I didn't think it was dangerous. I knew it was against the rules. I wasn't supposed to be administering anything like that to my horses

and I broke the rules.”

She used some of the samples for about a month but didn’t use them all and as she stated in her testimony never paid for any of Seth Fishman’s products.

Hall is under the impression that those products were sent for testing and nothing conclusive was found.

During that time one of her horses did win at Pompano Park, but he had dropped to the bottom class and was the 7-5 second choice, so there’s no way to determine if whatever she gave the horse had any effect.

Hall’s last conversation with Fishman was shortly after she arrived in New Jersey. He told her that he regretted ever trying to help her because she had been a huge waste of time, leading Hall to believe that Fishman may have been using her to get to more high-profile people she knew, like thoroughbred trainer Todd Pletcher, whom she had done administrative work for.

Following the trial, a list of Fishman’s clients was posted on the web. The list, however, does not show who bought what, so of the 2,000 clients, the majority could have purchased the horse equivalent of aspirin.

In the aforementioned press release, Gural also commented about Fishman’s list.

“We now have access to Seth Fishman’s customer database files, which contain the names of hundreds of his clients, including several prominent trainers who hopefully can produce records showing what they purchased and why,” said Gural.

The New Jersey Racing Commission (NJRC) is currently doing an investigation into Hall, so it’s unclear how much longer she will

be able to continue to race in New Jersey, but she is prepared for whatever judgement that is handed down by the NJRC.

“I made a huge mistake by doing that and I own it and I’m trying to get it right now,” said Hall.

Hall is currently trying to stay off social media because some of the comments have been beyond hurtful, especially from a couple of people that she thought were her friends.

Some have posted that since she admitted to cheating to gain an advantage she should not be allowed to race, while others appreciate her stepping forward as opposed to the hundreds that remained silent. Another said if she is tossed after she came forward, it will just enhance the secrecy.

Hall has also been accused of being a rat on social media, which is far from the truth. Fishman offered up the information on the wiretaps, and, in essence, ratted on himself.

In some of their conversations, Fishman talked to Hall about some of his high-profile clients and what some of them allegedly purchased. So, it was surprising to Hall that at least one of those clients bashed her on Facebook.

“This whole thing has been absolutely brutal on me, when in reality, I’m trying to help make it better,” she said. “These guys can say whatever they want about me, I don’t care. I had more balls than any of them to do what I did.”

The first crop of Odds On Equuleus made an immediate impact in the Hoosier State, producing five winners from nine starters led by \$270,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final winner Trick Of The Light p, 2, 1:51.1s (\$227,250). Odds On Equuleus was also represented by winners Odds On Number One p, 2, 1:54.3s (\$31,025), Odds On Alpha Male p, 2, 1:53s (\$23,970), and Premier On Stage p, 2, 1:52.4s (\$22,105). If the labs don't catch the cheaters, call Joe Friday

Dopers aren't scared of testing, but they are scared of something else.

I read with great interest the detailed and comprehensive *Times Union* piece, "N.Y. Lab Losing Battle of Doping in Horse Racing's Cat and Mouse Game" this week.

Some of the highlights, or lowlights if you prefer:

- "The so-called performance-enhancing drugs, no one — nobody — knows what they are. Nobody has a test for them."
- Joel Leveson, the Gaming Commission's former lead investigator and self-described "sheriff" of New York horse racing, said the problem now is "just as bad" as when he was chasing dopers from 1995 to 2014.
- "This really is a game of cat and mouse. The sophisticated cheater in this industry is very good at being a mouse."
- The New York Equine Drug Testing Lab and most similar facilities across the U.S. can only test for three varieties of EPO, while scientific literature cites 82 kinds of EPO worldwide. "Are they being used? I don't know. But they've been synthesized; they're available. So if you're testing for EPOs and you're only doing three and there are another 70-plus out there, who are you kidding?"
- Sometimes the lab will spend months working on a test for a substance only to find that trainers or owners willing to cheat have moved on to something else
- Individuals (garage chemists) monitor the literature, and they'll find a source — almost always from China — and they'll incorporate that into their work.

The New York lab's budget is \$5.5 million a year, and it's underfunded for the work they need to do. And, of course, there are more labs across North America doing similar tasks, all costing a considerable amount of money.

After reading the article, I came away depressed. The sport is spending time, money and sweat equity testing samples where the vast majority are from clean trainers who'd never cheat in a million years. Meanwhile, the potential positives are slipping through because the men and women in white coats are chasing ghosts.

Is there a better way?

As the story notes, there may be. The recent arrests and prosecution of several individuals allegedly involved in these escapades were not caught with positive tests, but with investigations.

No, it's not a new idea, but what if the labs continue to test to ensure available drugs are not being abused, and the sport puts the rest of the millions into investigators and law enforcement? Not a half-ass effort with one or two people in a jurisdiction which some already have, but a real push worthy of Allan Pinkerton.

I'm no expert on horse doping, but I imagine if I had a compound I knew wouldn't test I would sleep well, both before and after the pre-race injection. However, if I knew there were 10 people outside my door ready to barge in and send me to the big house while injecting it, I likely wouldn't. If I was constantly looking over my shoulder wondering when the knock comes or the sirens go, I would find life incredibly uncomfortable.

Being frightened and modifying our behavior is in our DNA. As the old adage goes, the hunter who ran away when he saw a rustling in a bush procreated the species, while his partner who decided to have a closer look was the tiger's lunch.

Maybe it's time to take some heat off the labs; the labs who are clearly trying but are up against a brick wall with no plausible end game. The white coats haven't scared people into changing their ways, but badges on every corner might.

Selling slots for the Mohawk Million coming down to the wire

This Tuesday (Feb. 15) looms as the date when nominations close for all major stakes at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 2022. Those stakes comprise over \$20 million in purses including the Breeders Crown which Woodbine plays host to this year, as well as a pair of \$1 million races.

One of those races with a seven-figure purse is the Pepsi North America Cup, and the other is the Mohawk Million for 2-year-old trotters. February 15 is particularly critical with respect to the Mohawk Million, because in order for the race to be a “go,” the nine race slots must be purchased by the nominating deadline (the 10th race slot is awarded to the winner of the William Wellwood Memorial at the end of August).

With the first of two \$50,000 fees for the Mohawk Million due in a few days, there is still work to be done to fill the race.

Bill McLinchey, the director of standardbred racing at Woodbine Entertainment, said Wednesday (Feb. 9) the race is not, yet, sold out.

“We’re close, but we’re not there yet,” McLinchey said. “We have to have nine (slots), and we have a few owners that are still thinking it over. I know it’s an investment and a big ask, and we really appreciate everyone that’s bought one, or even thinking about buying one.”

Aiming to set up for the third edition of the Mohawk Million, having slots open at this stage isn’t uncharted territory.

“The first two years that we had this race, I would say has gone right to the wire both times,” said McLinchey. “Going into this weekend, we’re almost at the exact spot that we were last year. I hope that we’re able to announce that it’s a go; I’m optimistic about it.”

Steve Heimbecker is one owner that said he has purchased a slot again this year. He told Woodbine communications ([full story here](#)): “From an owner’s perspective, racing for that kind of money in a prestigious race is a big attraction for me. I also

think it's nice because I love the racetrack at Mohawk. I really do think it is one of the best standardbred tracks in North America. And I love trotters."

Reasons for optimism stem from this being the third year of a race format that's gaining interest internationally. And specific to Woodbine, the Mohawk Million has been a success thus far despite being launched at the onset of a pandemic. Knock on wood, but it appears as though this should be the first time in three years that the racing calendar and stakes schedule at Woodbine won't be at the mercy of government-imposed shut-downs across the province. The first two years of the Mohawk Million, all required slots filled even though it was unknown if owners would be able to attend the race in person due to travel restrictions.

With presumed uninterrupted racing ahead for 2022, this year's stakes Woodbine returns to a more normal schedule. At the top of those stakes, is the placement of the Pepsi North America Cup from September last year, back to its traditional timeslot in June. Also, to be moved from late August and September and included on the June 18 North America Cup card are the Fan Hanover, Roses Are Red, Armbr Flight, Goodtimes and Mohawk Gold Cup Invitational.

Because of the stoppages last year, having to move the major early-summer stakes to later in the summer certainly provided logistical challenges for all racing parties, but at the same time it did create massive attention towards the track for about an eight-week period across August and September. Gearing up with an overabundance of major stakes almost immediately after the Hambletonian from the Meadowlands in early August, Woodbine became the extended center of the harness racing world, and it was reflected by the amount wagered on its product over that period.

From that success, I wondered if a case could be made to keep the stakes schedule as it was, focusing on a monster two-month period as summer concludes.

"I think after the success the races had in late August and early September, we certainly had to look at it and consider where we landed," said McLinchey. "The thing is, the North America

Cup was always successful in June as well. And what I kept coming back to was that for us, the North America Cup being the first major stake and where none of the top 3-year-olds have yet separated themselves from each other at that point. We've always been proud to be the first spot for them, where they race and not knowing who the best 3-year-old is at that point. It fits well, being first.

"Plus, I'm not sure if by having the North America Cup in September if it may have taken some air away from some of the other events like the Canadian Trotting Classic and so forth. But all in all, we've always been happy with the North America Cup in June and wanted to get back to that."

McLinchey also noted the scheduling not only as it pertains to conflicts with other major stakes at Woodbine, but also races conducted elsewhere.

"As we get into August and September, you're starting to get into the sire stake finals in other jurisdictions," McLinchey said. "We know the competition in the stake world is picking up with Kentucky as an example picking up steam, and racing in Ohio, Pennsylvania and New Jersey are rolling too, and we want to continue to make sure that we're one of the main options to race at."

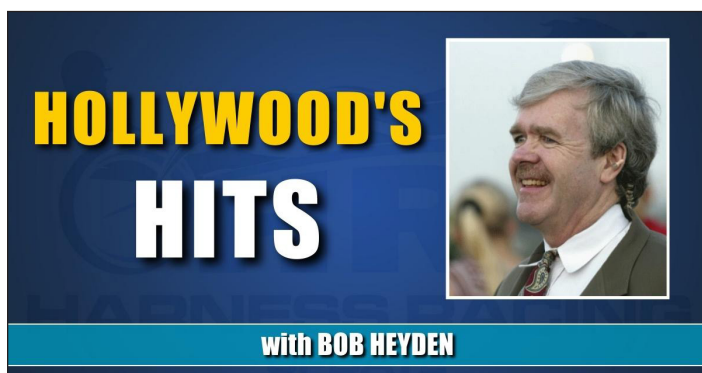

Everything you need to know about Super Bowl

Bear with me a bit. For 51 weeks of the year this won't fly. But for Super Bowl Week, I will empty the briefcase on the table. Thanks for the patience.

Super Bowl – the horse

Foaled in 1968, the same year the Jets made it to Super Bowl III on January 12, 1969.

The 1969 game was the first one referred to as the Super Bowl. The 1967 Packers-Chiefs and 1968 Packers-Raiders games were the "AFL-NFL Championship Games."

The trotter named Super Bowl raced from 1971-1972 out of Stanley Dancer's barn. He was tied for fifth in the Horse of the Year balloting in 1971.

His stablemate, Albatross, was the HOY in both 1971 and 1972.

Super Bowl was second in the HOY balloting in 1972 and won the Trotting Triple Crown setting five world records on Hambletonian Day.

He retired 38-for-51 and was the 1972 Trotter of the Year. That marked only the second time that a pacer and a trotter had gone 1-2 in HOY balloting. A decade earlier, Dancer did the same with Su Mac Lad and Henry T Adios (1962).

As a stallion, Super Bowl sired six Hambletonian winners (two before the Bengals' last appearance in the 1988 Super Bowl – four after). Only his sire, Stars Pride, did better with 8.

The Super Bowl-sired Hambletonian winners were:

1979 – Legend Hanover

1982 – Speed Bowl with Tommy Houghton, who is still the youngest to win the Hambletonian final at age 25. Two years earlier, Tommy became the youngest to win a heat with son of

Super Bowl (Final Score).

1989 – Probe was part of the legendary dead heat with Park Avenue Joe.

1991 – Giant Victory – Yes, the same year the Giants beat the Bills in the Super Bowl

1993 – American Winner (over Pine Chip, who was voted Trotter of the Year).

1995 – Tagliabue was the sixth and final son of Super Bowl to win the Hambletonian. (Super Bowl had the favorite in 1992, the filly Armbro Keepsake finished fourth).

Super Bowl was 25 years old when had his last Hambletonian credit.


Super Bird

Who is Super Bird and why was he included here?

Super Bird was the nickname of Albatross (sire of the winner of the first million-dollar race, Niatross).

Albatross was a stablemate to Super Bowl. Yes, he could fly, and he was the sport's first sub-1:55 race winner at both 3 and 4. He was the sport's first million-dollar winner covering two straight seasons (1971-1972).

Both he and Super Bowl set the all-time single season records for any age as sophomores – Super Bowl (\$436,258) in 1972 and Albatross (\$558,009) in 1971.

This year marks the 50th anniversary of this epic duo racing together – going 1-2 in HOY balloting something that would not be repeated by stablemates for 40 years until Linda Toscano did it in 2012 with Chapter Seven and Market Share.

Albatross was 59-for-71 career, Super Bowl 38-for-51. The combined record for Albatross and Super Bowl in 1972 was 48-for-56.

No wonder they got 182-of-191 votes cast for HOY between them.

Albatross was the division winner in all three years he raced, his 2-year-old season under the tutelage of Harry Harvey and then to Dancer.

Super Bowl also won his division both seasons on the track at 2 and 3.

Together, they won 5-of-6 Triple Crown races between them.

Enter Hanover Shoe Farms. Super Bowl arrived three weeks ahead of Albatross.

The #1 standardbred farm in the world would be the home for these two for the next quarter century. Side by side again. Neither ever knew any other home.

Super Bowl, the first sire to have three Breeders Crown winners in a single year (1985) was still active in 1997 (94 mares). He died on October 2, 1998.

Albatross made it to August 5, 1998 – at age 30.

They dominated in the stallion ranks. With their first crops stepping onto the track the same year the Meadowlands opened, both rose to the top of the breeding ranks (Super Bowl and Speedy Crown as a unique siring tandem) No one has ever surpassed the \$75,000 Albatross sire fee and nobody has ever had three straight Horses of the Year with two different horses – 1979-1980 Niatross and 1981 Fan Hanover.

Super Bowl and his sire Stars Pride combined for 14 Hambletonians.

No trotting sire and no pacing sire have ever had more foals than these two who could not be, and would not be, separated both on and off the track.

They were even 1-2 in Hall of Fame honors. The Living Horse Hall Of Fame started in 1996. Albatross was inducted year one, Super Bowl in year two.

Football and racing

Ken Stabler, the 1976 Super Bowl winner with the Raiders, was part of the “George Plimpton Challenge” and made it to the Meadowlands in 1987.

Willie Lanier was a great middle linebacker for the outstanding

KC Chiefs games of the 1970s. He was at the Big M several times. Richard Caster, the tight end for the NY Jets, participated in the Celebrity Challenge races.

Joe Namath was at the Meadowlands on opening night in 1976 with his agent and the man most responsible for the advent of night harness racing in New Jersey – Sonny Werblin.

Paul McGuire, NBC football announcer, was a good friend of the sport of racing and a participant in some amateur events.

Wellington Mara and Leon Hess, owners of the NY Jets and NY Giants. Never will I forget them coming into the press box at the Meadowlands together from the President's Room to make a \$2 bet – each!

Redskin, the 1987 Messenger winner, was and is the all-time highest-earning 2-year-old ever at \$1.407 million in 1986.

Drop The Ball, the outstanding filly for Eric Cherry, actually tried her hand in the 2011 Meadowlands Pace eliminations versus the boys.

Wayne Chrebet – Talk about the good guys. He was a fan favorite receiver for the NY Jets and an avid harness owner.

Fake Left, the 1992 Little Brown Jug winner was part of a one-time Meadowlands-only happening. Two \$100 horses, one night, same driver, same track. Cat Manzi July 31, 1991. Manzi got them both home – \$191 for Fake Left then a 2-year-old and \$100.60 for Hundred Kisses, who a few years later celebrated the Jug and the entire Triple Crown with her son Blissfull Hall.

Look here

Super Bowl 56 – Feb. 13, 2022. Dave Palone turns 60.

These are Palone's lifetime numbers as of Feb. 10:

76,791 starts, 19,856 wins, \$151,342,736.

Yes, the countdown to 20,000 is well underway.

The first NFL passer to reach 20,000 yards was Sammy Baugh (1950 – 20,630).

Herve Filion was the first to drive 20,000 times.

Speaking of Filion, Palone broke Filion's record for wins as a driver with his 15,181st on July 5, 2012 at The Meadows (Herculotte Hanover).

Palone hit 15,000 just six weeks after turning 50 that year.

He won his first race the same year the Bengals debuted in the Super Bowl in 1981.

Palone went into the Hall Of Fame in 2010.

He became the world's driving leader in November, 2014 with his 16,754th victory.

Nine trotters gather behind the gate while six horses will begin in second line and Davidson du Pont will start from post 8 behind the car.

Prix de France 2022 features 14 horses that raced Prix d'Amérique and the only trotter that is "new" is Fakir du Lorault.

Title defender Delia du Pommereux (disarmed Face Time Bourbon over the stretch in last year's edition of Prix de France) hasn't showed the best form this season but she is still in the race on Sunday and there are several horses that are favored by the shorter distance, compared to Prix d'Amérique.

Harness racing in Florida not dead, yet

Representative Dan Daley's House Bill 1269 calls for recoupling Florida harness racing.

April 17, 2022 appears on the calendar as the last-ever race date for Isle Casino Racing Pompano Park, although the live racing schedule footnote reads “dates subject to change.” What isn’t changing is The Cordish Companies and Eldorado Resorts’ plan to put a “world-class, mixed-use hospitality destination” on the South Florida racetrack property their “Live! Resorts Pompano” web page describes as “undeveloped” and “one of the best opportunities for development in the United States.”

The proverbial horse has left the barn, as far as racing is concerned: A 55,454-square-foot Publix grocery/liquor store and ten smaller commercial retail buildings will anchor the project, according to Pompano! Magazine real estate and development reporter Marie Puleo.

What is left, now that the decisions about Florida’s only pari-mutuel harness track are final? Last time Harness Racing Update checked in with Dan Daley, Democratic Representative for District 97, it was a little too soon to disclose much about future House Bill 1269, “a bill to be entitled ‘An act relating to pari-mutuel wagering.’” Filed by Daley on Jan. 6, 2022, HB 1269 is a bill to protect harness racing. It was submitted to the Florida House of Representatives and subsequently referred to the Regulatory Reform Subcommittee, State Administration and Technology Appropriations Subcommittee, and Commerce Committee on Jan. 12, 2022.

On Dec. 9, 2021, Daley explained how relocating pari-mutuel harness racing would be a substantial undertaking in the Sunshine State.

“You would need the opportunity to get that [standardbred racing] permit, which requires legal action, requires a bill and a law to permit you to do that. It is a heavy lift, because any piece of legislation is a heavy lift. But then also, candidly, you would need somebody willing to open that track, right? You need money; you need purses; you need somebody to build a grandstand. You’re talking about a not-so-small investment to open a track in Florida,” he said.

He added that other forms of on-site gaming (slots, table games, etc.) would not be automatically approved for a new harness track: “It’s probably a separate decision. I think they’re probably going to have to follow the standard route, only a little backwards: Normally, you would apply for a harness racing permit and then you would go through a process of getting slots approved because you have the harness racing permit. Here, we don’t have a harness racing permit [after Pompano closes]; we don’t really have the ability to apply for a harness racing permit. So unless we grant one in legislation, which is what I’m thinking about doing [he said Dec. 9, 2021], they’re not going to have the opportunity and then you couldn’t get slots. But down the road, could you potentially? Yeah, you could, potentially.”

The property owners cannot be compelled to keep racing in order to retain casino gaming at Live! Resorts Pompano, which will include expanded casino space, a two-floor sports bar, and a Professional Bull Riders’ zone with a mechanical bull.

“They’ve already won the other legal battle that says they’re allowed to transfer their permit from a harness racing permit to a jai alai permit,” said Daley. “As far as they’re concerned, they’re done.”

He said that Florida harness racing’s future will be decided elsewhere.

“It’s about: Are you going to be able to have standardbred racing at all in the state? Short of a new piece of legislation that I’m considering filing [i.e. HB 1269, which Daley filed January 6, 2022], or a legal victory, we’re not.

“Look, even if you had someone that was interested [as of Dec. 9, 2021], let’s assume that [the Seminole Tribe sports betting] court case* doesn’t go our way, you would need a piece of

legislation to even give them the opportunity to go race,” he told HRU. “Right now, there’s no mechanism. Let’s say you have a wealthy guy out of Ocala that wants to throw \$20 million at this – they don’t have the opportunity to get a permit. So that’s what the legislation would likely do, is give someone the opportunity to apply for a standardbred racing permit... I don’t mean to get too in the weeds with it, it’s just that there are a lot of different moving parts and I understand it more today than I did, certainly a year ago.”

(*When Bill CS/SB 2-A was thrown out in US federal appeals court last November, the Seminole Tribe of Florida’s gaming compact was no longer valid, taking away its Hard Rock Sportsbook sports wagering monopoly in the state. Florida harness racing supporters had hoped that “companion bill” 8-A (2021A), which introduced standardbred-only decoupling alongside Bill CS/SB 2-A, would be automatically invalidated as well. Bill King has noted in Sports Business Journal that the Seminoles’ current appeal is unlikely to be settled until at least June 2022.)

In mid-February, much depends on the fate of HB 1269, which includes amendments to previous wording that would allow existing Florida gaming venues to apply for a pivot to standardbred racing:

A greyhound [racing] permitholder, jai alai permitholder, thoroughbred permitholder, or quarter horse racing permitholder that held such permit during the 2020-2021 operating year may elect to conduct live harness horse racing. Authorization to conduct harness horse racing pursuant to this chapter may only be granted to a permitholder that held an operating license to conduct pari-mutuel wagering for fiscal year 2020-2021 or that holds a permit... Live harness horse racing may only be conducted pursuant to this chapter if such permitholder qualifies to retain the greyhound permit, jai alai permit, thoroughbred permit, or quarter horse racing permit held during the 2020-2021 operating year. Authorization granted to conduct harness horse racing to a permitholder other than a harness horse racing permitholder is not considered granting or issuance of a permit or license, or a conversion of such permit, but is merely considered an additional benefit of holding a greyhound permit, jai alai permit, thoroughbred permit, or quarter horse racing permit.

Daley said he believes there is support for the bill, which must still meet approval within a specific, narrow timeframe.

“There’s only so much time. It’s a 60-day window. If you can’t get the bill moving in that 60 days, it dies.”

If passed into law, the act will come into effect on July 1, 2022; holders of horse/dog racing and jai alai permits would then be able to apply before Oct. 1, 2022 to host live harness racing in Florida.

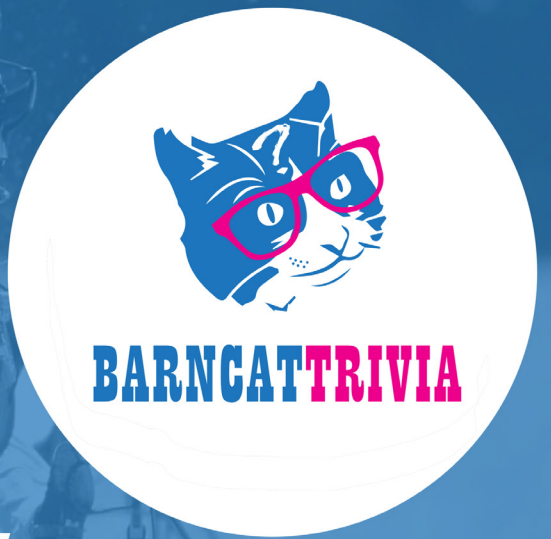

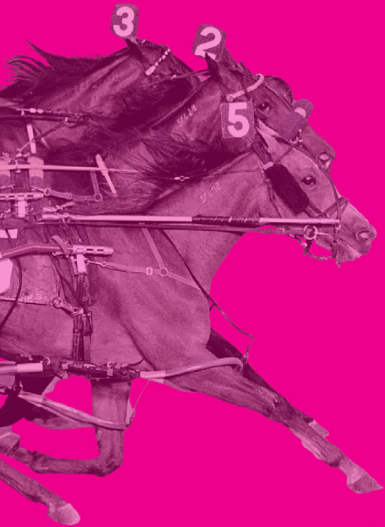

Verruso sky-high over racing

Anthony Verruso looks back on his 2021 season on the amateur driving circuit with a bit of disbelief. A lifelong resident of the New York City borough of Queens, the 58-year-old Verruso notched 23 wins last year — a total that represents more than one-fifth of the 107 career victories he has accumulated since he began competing in 1999.

In addition to getting his 100th lifetime win last year, Verruso earned his first-ever victory at The Meadowlands, which came in a division of the Hambletonian Amateur Trot on Aug. 6, and recorded his first driving double, which came at the Big M three months later.

At the end of December, Verruso was named the Amateur Driver of the Year by the U.S. Harness Writers Association. He will be recognized for his accomplishments at USHWA's Dan Patch Awards banquet Feb. 20 at Rosen Shingle Creek resort in Orlando.

"There are so many drivers, the fact that I would get picked is an honor," Verruso said. "It's nice to be recognized for something you really love doing."

Verruso set career highs across the board last year, with 84 starts, his aforementioned 23 wins, \$175,545 in purses, and .421 universal driver rating.

"I look at it and laugh," Verruso said. "I'm not bragging, but I look, and the UDRS is ridiculous. Everything just worked last year. I got in a new barn with (trainer) Symon Spicer, and he likes the amateur races. Every week as one horse became ineligible, because we have money conditions, another horse fit. It was just perfect.

"It's mostly the horse. Maybe you eke out a couple of good-drive wins, but if you don't have the horse, you're not winning. It's that simple."

Verruso, who for the past 11 years has worked as a flight attendant for JetBlue, grew up going to the races at Roosevelt and Yonkers. It wasn't until he was in his early 30s, though, that he decided to become a hands-on participant. Every Saturday, he

traveled to Showplace Farms in central New Jersey and learned from trainer Howard Beal and driver Harold Kelly.

"I'm kind of a city kid who never grew up around horses," Verruso said. "When I first started, I had little to no experience at all except for watching races. I watched my whole life. It was about getting the experience of doing to match what I knew from watching. Then it started to fall into place. But it took a while."

Verruso wears the same colors as Kelly in tribute to his mentor, who passed away in 2020.

"I was very happy that he was happy about that," Verruso said. "His family loves it. They say it's so great to still see the colors. It's a really nice thing."

Verruso got his first win in 2001 in a Billings Series amateur trot at Goshen Historic Track. The triumph came with From One To Sixty, a horse he owned that was trained by Marion Sumpf. He added 24 wins over the ensuing eight years while averaging 35 starts a season. From there, opportunities for amateurs began to gradually increase, and with it so did Verruso's starts and victories.

"The first eight to 10 years, you were lucky if you raced once a week," Verruso said. "Now, a couple of weeks ago, I raced five times on the weekend. It's a big difference. That helps."

Entering last year, Verruso had won at 26 different tracks in eight different states and Canada. The Meadowlands was not among the group, but he picked up four victories there in 2021, including career win 100.

"It was one of the few tracks I had never won at, for whatever reason," Verruso said. "The 100th win, that was great. My family was there. It was sent out as my Christmas card."

In addition to driving, Verruso owns four horses, which he believes is a benefit of people participating in harness racing as amateurs.

"If I wasn't driving, there is no chance I would own four race-horses," Verruso said. "None. Zero. So, it does help the sport to some degree in that regard."

And while Verruso is happy to win races, he is more interested in continuing to develop his skills as a driver.

"Obviously, everyone wants to be the best at something," Verruso said. "But that wasn't my thing. It's more the respect of horsemen was important to me. And the fact that people seem to now acknowledge that I'm at least capable."

"It's great that I have something I really enjoy doing," he added. "So many of my friends say they have nothing to do, or all they do is play golf. I play golf, but I don't look forward to it. This, I look forward to it every week. Where did I draw, what is going on, who is in. It's a big deal."

Verruso will drive in both of tonight's (Feb. 11) GSY Series amateur races at The Meadowlands. The events are races four and seven. First-race post time is 6:20 p.m. EST. For a free online program, courtesy of TrackMaster, visit The Meadowlands' website [here](#).

Howard (Doc) Gill dead at 95

Iconic Orange County (NY) harness horse veterinarian Dr. Howard E. (Doc) Gill, died Monday, (Feb. 7) at his home in Perdido Key, FL.

Howard Gill was born Sept. 25, 1926, the son of Howard and Edith Kaufman Gill. Upon graduation from Cherryvale High School in Kansas, he went on to serve his country in the US Navy. Following his stint in the armed service, Gill graduated from Independence Junior College and went on to Kansas State University where he earned his doctorate in veterinary medicine. While at Kansas State Gill was also a scholar-athlete, playing football at KSU as a halfback and a safety. Gill held the Wildcats punt return record for almost 50 years.

A horse enthusiast from an early age, as well as a renowned equine veterinarian, Gill specialized in reproduction and surgery serving on the college staff of Kansas State and at Michigan State where his mentoring began and continued throughout his life. In 2008, Gill was honored with the American Association of Equine Practitioners' Distinguished Educators Award for his work as a faculty member at Michigan State.

'Doc Gill,' as he was known by his many clients and admirers, worked for decades in the Hudson Valley of New York in private practice, founding Pine Bush Equine, which ultimately grew into one of the premier veterinary practices in the state.

One of Gill's true passions was the breeding, breaking, training and racing of Standardbred racehorses. While Gill semi-retired from his vet practice, he never really slowed down and continued to drive and train well into his eighties.

Most fans fondly remember his homebred Miss Gibbons 1:52.3 (\$297,312), a New York Sires Stakes Horse of the Year with 28 wins and several track records to her credit. Owned, bred, trained and driven by Doc Gill, the Giant Hit mare provided the octogenarian with many thrills and accolades wherever they traveled to race.

Following a victory at Monticello Raceway in 2007 Gill told public relations guru John Manzi, "I looked forward to it then and even more so now because it keeps me young — though my wife Irene would prefer that I slow down," he said. "I keep telling her that someday I will — but that'll be a sad day in my life when I do."

Throughout his years of working in the horse industry he enjoyed the many friends and colleagues that were a part of his life. He was also a member of the Christian Harness Horseman's Association, recognizing the importance of faith and eternal life. His family felt very blessed to have shared such a long, prosperous life with Gill. They are extremely grateful for the precious time they had with him over the past few years, despite his failing health.

Gill was predeceased by his parents and two brothers Don and Jim Gill. He is survived by his very devoted wife at home, Irene Denton Gill of 67 years; son Stanley Gill (Susan); daughters Anne Gill Syphard (Jack); Jane Watt (Stuart); six grandchildren: Natalie Quintana Brown (Ted); Andrew Quintana; Luke Gill (Daniel); Samuel Gill; Claire Reutter and William Reutter; two great grandchildren, Owen and Collin Brown.

Services will be private. A celebration of Doc Gill's life will be held this July in Goshen during the Historic Track Grand Circuit meet.

Memorial contributions can be made on his behalf to two organizations that Doc Gill was passionate about: Christian Harness Horsemen's Association and/or New Vocations Adoption Program.

Breeders Crown introduces foreign stallion fee for limited North American foal eligibility

The Hambletonian Society, which owns and administers the \$6.7 million Breeders Crown year-end championship series, has created a special stallion fee deadline that will provide eligibility to the Breeders Crown program for a limited number of North American foals by foreign stallions.

Stallion nomination has been the cornerstone of Breeders Crown eligibility since the program was created in 1983. Typically, when a stallion pays an annual stud fee plus applicable surcharges, the entire foal crop for that year is eligible. There are currently 131 stallions paid in to Breeders Crown No. 39 (breedings of 2022; foals of 2023), and they can be viewed here:

“With the increasing crossover interest in European sires we wanted to find a way to be inclusive of those North American breeders and owners who are interested in incorporating foreign bloodlines into their programs. After much discussion, we think we have reached a fair avenue for those limited crops to participate, and create even more international interest in the Crown,” said John Campbell, president and CEO of the Hambletonian Society.

The additional March 15, 2022 deadline to pay in only foreign stallions at the rate of one stud fee, will cover up to 15 North American foaled and registered offspring. Those foals would then be able to make yearling and subsequent year’s payments to participate in the Crown program. Additionally, any foals by Foreign Stallions that are foaled and registered in North America from mares bred outside of North America [whether or not by frozen semen] may be made eligible by payment no later than March 15, in the amount of the advertised stallion fee in the jurisdiction where the stallion stands in 2022. This

payment does not apply to 2023 foals that are foaled outside of North America.

The connections of legendary French trotter Face Time Bourbon have already expressed interest in making a North American crop eligible to future Breeders Crowns.

Gural Rule revised

The Meadowlands is announcing a revision to the Stallion Restriction Condition (SRC) aka the "Gural Rule" that is effective immediately.

From 2022 forward, horses 4 years of age and older that are sired by horses excluded from stakes by the SRC will be eligible for nomination to those stakes.

The language has been changed by adding a 6th clause to the existing text as highlighted below:

Beginning with foals of 2018 and continuing thereafter, all foals conceived by a sire less than five years of age WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE to be nominated to or race in any stakes in which this Stallion Restriction Condition (SRC) is in effect unless the sire (or nominated horse) is exempted from this condition by the Sponsors by meeting one or more of the following exemptions:...

...(6) The nominated horse is 4 years old and older

"The spirit of the rule is to try and keep our stars racing, so excluding older horses from our stakes was not our intention," Meadowlands president Jeff Gural explained. "There are some horse returning to the races from age 3 to 4 this year that are of the quality that we'd like to see continue to race. This had not previously been considered and needs to be corrected rather than exclude those horses by the SRC."

"The rule remains intact for the two- and three-year-old stakes but we are modifying it to give the horses that do come back after three the opportunity to race in our stakes."

The Big Game headlines a big weekend at Big M

Meadowlands fans are in store for a special weekend, in fact, you could say after two days of the best harness racing anywhere, they will then go "Big Game Hunting."

The mile oval will have live harness racing on Friday (Feb. 11) and Saturday (Feb. 12) before the track's FanDuel Sportsbook will be the hottest spot in town on Sunday (Feb. 13), the day of the National Football League's championship game.

Tonight's (Feb. 11) 13-race card will get underway at 6:20 p.m.

with temperatures during the night expected to be 30 degrees warmer than a week ago. The man with the hottest hands in harness racing, driver Yannick Gingras, will look to stay on a roll in the early stages of the Winter Meeting. The 42-year-old Hall of Fame bound pilot, who's won at least three races during seven of the eight race cards contested at The Meadowlands thus far this year, had five victories last Saturday to up his driver-colony-leading total to 31.

They'll be a carryover of \$8,572 offered Friday on the 20-cent Pick-6 after no winning tickets were sold last Saturday. Like last week, the final pool is likely to offer a "negative takeout", when more money is returned to the bettors who go six-for-six than what is wagered in "new money."

Saturday will bring another 6:20 p.m. post time for the first of 13 dashes, with one of the races standing above the rest.

Race eight is the \$40,000 Sweetheart Pace, an event for Preferred mares, where seven of the nine horses in the field have lifetime earnings of over \$300,000. Machnhope, Racine Bell and Alexa Skye are among the entrants who will be familiar to Big M regulars.

On Sunday, the joint will be jumping, with simulcasting all day and football all night.

In the NFL's title tilt, the game between the Los Angeles Rams and Cincinnati Bengals kicks off at 6:30 p.m. The Rams are a four-point favorite who are -198 on the money line. The under/over is 48½.

If prop bets are your thing, you can try total passing yards for the two starting quarterbacks. Cincinnati's Joe Burrow's number is 276½, and you can get -110 if you think he will have less or more. The number for the Rams' Matthew Stafford is 281½ and both the over and under also are -110.

How about something a little different? If you want to wager that the game will go into overtime, you can get +1040. Game ends in regulation? That's -2000. If you think the Rams' Aaron Donald will record a sack, your odds are -192. If you think he won't do it, you can get +150.

Come on out to the sportsbook, located in the grandstand at The Meadowlands, to watch and wager on the action. Hours for the book are Monday through Thursday from 10 a.m.-1 a.m.; Friday 10 a.m.-2 a.m.; Saturday 7 a.m.-2 a.m. and Sunday 8 a.m.-12 a.m.

According to survey results released Tuesday by the American Gaming Association (AGA), the game is setting up to be the most heavily bet ever with an estimated \$7.61 billion potentially on the line. Another estimation projects that 31.4 million American adults plan on betting the game.

"The results are clear," said Bill Miller, president of the AGA. "Americans have never been more interested in legal sports wagering."

WATCH THE BIG GAME: The Meadowlands is offering football fans several options to watch the game on Sunday. There will be seating in the Victory Outdoor Heated Pavilion, seating at tables in the Grandstand Lounge and couch seating in the Grandstand

Lounge. All areas will offer great dining options as well.

Mass Sire Stake continuation payments due on Feb. 15

Anyone who is eligible to compete in the 2022 Massachusetts Sire Stakes should take note that continuation payments are due on Tuesday (Feb. 15). The stakes that start on Sunday (Sept. 25) have an estimated total value of \$2.24 million and will be contested in three \$60,000 preliminary legs for each age, gender and gait followed by eight \$100,000 finals on Monday (Oct. 24).

The qualifying rule has been changed from 30 days to 45 days.

Also, new guidelines for qualifying times are as follows: 2-year-old pacers must go in 2:05 and 2-year-old trotters in 2:07. 3-year-old pacers must go in 2:03 and 3-year-old trotters in 2:05.

And lastly in order to be eligible for the final, a horse must have started in at least two of the three preliminary legs.

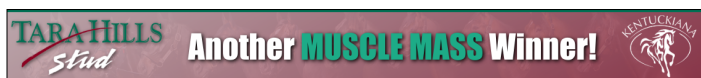

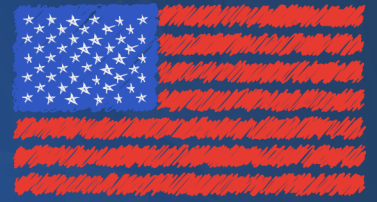
