Appeal-ing Pace victory for Charlie May

On Friday (Feb. 10), a judge declared Charlie May the winner of the 2021 Meadowlands Pace and although it was a great victory for owner Don Tiger and his team, the case is far from over.

In a 15-page [decision](#), New Jersey Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), Andrew M. Baron, said, in part, "I hereby ORDER that the determination of the track side judges which was sustained by the Racing Commission must be REVERSED, as it was arbitrary, capricious and unjust, and violated petitioner's fundamental due process rights, and the rights of the wagering public, whose interests the track side judges, and the Racing Commission are supposed to protect as well. I FURTHER ORDER that Charlie May should be reinstated as the winner of the Meadowlands Pace which was held on July 17, 2021."

Baron's decision is now on file with the New Jersey Racing Commission (NJRC) to either be accepted, rejected or modified and their next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, March 22 at The Meadowlands, but no agenda is currently available.

“There’s still a long way to go, but we’re in a good spot,” Tiger said.

It’s been nearly 19 months since Tiger **appealed the disqualification** of his homebred Charlie May’s victory in the Pace.

At that time, a large motivating factor was the hope of being able to race in the Little Brown Jug, which as the Pace winner, he would be eligible to do.

“I wouldn’t say that was the only premise, but it was a big part of it,” Tiger said. “Because when I tried to adjudicate it, I just wanted to get in the Jug because, obviously, the horse is an Ohio bred. Hometown race, hometown trainer and I thought if we could get the proper ruling, we could get into the Jug.”

Tiger has always seen his fight as one for the little guy – David versus Goliath, if you will – but also for doing what is right and holding people accountable.

Tiger has never faltered in his belief that Southwind Gendry – not Charlie May – was responsible for causing the chain reaction, and yet, Southwind Gendry was not investigated by the judges.

“It was just a huge, egregious error from top to bottom,” Tiger said. “The judges missed the interference on [Southwind Gendry] and then they didn’t do their due diligence.

“That’s why Judge Baron ruled in our favor I’m pretty sure, because the facts are the facts. We got no due process and they didn’t do their job that day.”

What can be gained from reading the entire decision is that Baron found Tiger’s expert witness to be credible and the NJRC’s to be “uncomfortable” and, at times, “evasive.”

Attorney Howard Taylor was not part of this case and did not witness the proceedings, but he is an expert on administrative law cases.

“You can ask the [New Jersey Racing] Commission, I try more of these than everybody else combined or as many as everybody else combined,” Taylor said. “And in this particular case this judge seems to – in his opinion – have gone to great lengths to assess the credibility of the witnesses more so than any opinion I ever remember reading.

“Usually, a judge doesn’t want to insult somebody by attacking their credibility. This judge, in this opinion, didn’t seem to mind. I’ve rarely seen that.”

Regardless of how strongly the ALJ worded his decision, based on Taylor’s previous experiences in New Jersey, he believes the NJRC will reject it.

“If I was a betting man,” Taylor said with a laugh. “I would expect that the Commission will overturn [the ALJ’s decision] and reinstate the [racetrack] judges’ decision. And I will tell you without fear of contradiction, I can’t remember a case – I’m sure there’s been, but none come to mind – where the racetrack judges’ decision was overturned and it wasn’t reinstated by the Commission.

“I’ve had [administrative law] judges come to me – I’d say three or four, but more than two – and say they don’t like hearing racing cases because they feel like their opinion doesn’t matter because whatever they say is irrelevant and gets overturned.”

Taylor has tried horse racing cases in at least eight different states – Delaware, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, New Jersey, New York, Ohio and Pennsylvania – and has never had the commission overturn the ALJ’s decision until New Jersey where he’s done more of these cases than in other states.

“And I’ve never had a case where they didn’t reinstate the initial decision in Jersey,” Taylor said. “It’s a complete perversion of the system. And it’s only the racing commission, it’s not the State of New Jersey. Only the racing commission routinely ignores what the ALJ says.”

Should the NJRC reject the ALJ’s decision, as Taylor believes they will, the next step is for Tiger’s team to file an appeal to the appellate division of the New Jersey superior court, buy and review the transcript and prepare a brief, which will once again have Tiger reaching for his checkbook.

Tiger has already incurred substantial legal fees in this fight, which in an interview on the [Harness Racing Alumni Show](#), he said are “pushing up on six figures,” but regardless of that he is committed to seeing this case through to what he hopes will be a win for the integrity of harness racing.

“Their bylaws say to adjudicate racing and exhaust any and all measures to do that,” Tiger said. “They didn’t do that that day. That’s the whole premise here. And they just made a rush to judgement. All they did is see a horse that broke stride and the guys up in the booth said ‘Yeah, he broke stride, let’s take him down, let’s move on.’”

“In a race of that magnitude, they should have made a call and said to Brett Miller, ‘What happened out there?’ That’s all it

would have taken. Because they acknowledged that they never investigated [Southwind Gendry] in their testimony. That was huge. So, they basically are on record as saying that they didn’t do their job.”

Just as other professional sports – baseball, basketball, football, hockey – have embraced technology such as instant replay to try and get calls right, Tiger hopes harness racing will continue to do the same. There may be an occasional missed call, but by following the rules it won’t be arbitrary and capricious because they will have exhausted any and all measures.

“No judges want to talk to drivers per se but they have to talk to drivers because you have to get a complete depiction of what happened and then still make your judgement call,” Tiger said. “But that’s where they erred again. You just have to talk to people and they didn’t do it.”

“All you’re trying to do is piece everything together. You’re trying on a rainy night, on an off track, to get a complete depiction of what happened. That’s all. If they would have called Brett Miller the first thing he would have said is ‘Dude, I was going to get into an accident if I didn’t pull the right line.’”

Should the NJRC indeed reinstate the original racetrack judges’ decision, Taylor feels confident that Tiger’s chances are excellent with the appellate court thanks to the thorough work of ALJ Baron.

“My opinion is that they would take that into heavy consideration,” Taylor said. “So, I think Tiger would have a good chance of

winning at the appellate level because the judge went out of his way to give his opinion as to the credibility of these witnesses. And I think the appellate division will take note of that and give extra consideration for that.”

For Tiger, now it's just about waiting to see what the NJRC does.

“We're not going to stop,” Tiger said. “We'll keep going especially due to how strong the opinion was of Judge Andrew Baron. We'll take it to the appellate level and the state supreme court and the national supreme court, if needed. We'll keep going.”

For any that think Tiger's motivation could be purse driven with the opportunity to recoup some of his considerable legal fees, that is not the case. From day one he has said it's not about the money and should he be given the rightful Pace purse, he will donate it.

“Thankfully, Charlie's made some nice money and we're able to afford this,” Tiger said. “And I think it's going to help someone else down the road. I really do.

“This case isn't surrounding whether a horse interfered with another horse or whether judges made a call right or wrong. It's about due process and fundamental fairness and it wasn't administered that day and it wasn't administered in the weeks after.”

One thing lost in all the recent discussions about this case is how this decision affects Lawless Shadow, who was elevated to the Pace win with the disqualification of Charlie May.

According to Taylor, the connections of Lawless Shadow should have been invited to be part of the proceedings by the NJRC since they had a vested interest. But according to Lawless Shadow's co-owner/trainer Dr. Ian Moore, they were never asked.

“I didn't even know anything was going on, actually, to tell you the truth until I read it the other day,” said Moore. “Really, we're basically just a casual observer in this whole thing because it wasn't like he ran into us. Which would be a totally different situation. We just happened to be there and be in the race and you know the story. So, I don't know what that means either.”

Charlie May ruling illustrates need for inquiry standardization

Hambletonian Society president John Campbell weighs in.

In his decision last Friday to reverse the New Jersey Racing Commission's (NJRC) disqualification of Charlie May from the 2021 Meadowlands Pace, Judge Andrew Baron took exception to how the inquiry immediately following that race was conducted. Particularly, with regards to input from race participants not being solicited.

As part of his ruling, Baron states, in reference to Petitioner/Don Tiger's expert witness Art Gray, "Of interest towards the end of Mr. Gray's testimony was the fact that at a meeting of regional race officials that took place four months after Charlie May was disqualified, the officials in attendance agreed and adopted something now referred to as the "Charlie May rule," which calls on race officials in their due diligence when the outcome of a race is called into question when interference is alleged, to interview as many drivers and others involved before rendering a decision that may result in disqualification of a winning horse."

Regardless of if the NJRC elects to adopt or reject Baron's recommended decision, the "Charlie May rule" as it was referred to in the ruling is a much-needed step in the right direction. As is standard operating procedure within thoroughbred racing, all involved riders (drivers, in this case), should be required to communicate with judges during an inquiry and provide their on-track perspective for whatever events are subject on an inquiry. It's hard to believe that hasn't already been the case.

Perhaps one reason why it isn't part of standard procedure depending on the jurisdiction, is because there is a sense among some that judges simply don't need the driver input. That judges are placed in their positions to determine specifically these matters on their own and that video evidence alone is sufficient.

From his own experience, Hall of Fame driver and Hambletonian Society president John Campbell believes that even with driver input, judges' decisions almost always come down to the video.

"This would be in the late 1980s or early 1990s, and I had a disagreement with a judge," Campbell said. "He wasn't happy with what I had told him over an inquiry, so I went in the next morning and spoke to him. I said, 'You know what, don't call me anymore. When we have to go by what is on the video, then it doesn't matter what I say. It's either on the video or it's not. If it's appealed, all the decisions are going to come down to what's on that video. You have the advantage of looking at it from all the angles. You just make the call from what you see on the video, and I'll be fine with it.'"

Interestingly, Campbell confirmed that he was not contacted by the judges during another highly controversial disqualification; the take-down of him and Odds On Equuleus in the 2012 Bluegrass Stakes at the Red Mile for what judges said was abruptly slowing the pace. Though at least one driver was interviewed, Campbell — who was found to cause confusion among trailing horses — was not.

Campbell concedes that sometimes there can be a misconception on video as to what actually occurred in a race, but he reiterates that ultimately decisions from judges come down to what's on video. And while he can't say if drivers should be part of a standard inquiry process since he's never been a judge, Campbell does strongly believe in a consistent process.

The judges work for the commission, so they should be instructing them on how they want their inquiries to be conducted.”

Even if the judges had talked to Charlie May’s driver, Brett Miller, would his side of the story have been enough to warrant not disqualifying the horse in the Meadowlands Pace? From Campbell’s experience, it likely would not have changed the outcome. But the basis for Tiger’s successful appeal was that he wasn’t afforded due process because of the lack of due diligence (i.e., not talking to race participants) more-so than the events that transpired on the track. Though, it is noteworthy that in this case, the Administrative Law Judge concluded differently than the Racing Commission’s judges as to what the video replay showed.

For now, the “Charlie May rule” refers to processes I believe that’s being formulated starting with the state of New Jersey, but it’s something that should expand to all other jurisdictions that don’t currently have input from race participants as part of their inquiry decision making process. Even if judges feel they don’t necessarily want or even need the input, accumulating more information only leads to further transparency.

As part of ALJ Baron’s ruling, it was documented that the outcome of races should not only be safeguarded for its contestants, but for the public at large too. In establishing a precedent where further due diligence must be performed, the current win for Charlie May could turn out to be a win for all of us.

Italian joy as Ampia Mede SM wins Prix de France

Fabrice Souloy-trained mare **Ampia Mede SM** (Ganymede) didn't get anything for free in Sunday's (Feb. 12) \$420,000 Prix de France and when she disarmed leader Don Fanucci Zet via a first over trip and held attackers behind her in the finish.

The Italian-bred trotter followed up her runner-up performance in Prix d'Amérique with a great victory in one of the world's biggest 1.3 mile races for trotters and she established her position as one of the best mares in Europe. Ampia Mede SM had a successful meeting in Paris last season and this year has been even better for her. After the two bronze medals in Prix de Bretagne and Prix de Bourgogne, respectively, Fabrice Souloy hit the highest possible level with his 7-year-old trotter in the big grand prix-races at Vincennes.

Driver Franck Nivard was eager to put Ampia Mede SM in a spot in front of the Prix de France field and when the 18 horses found their positions, she had to settle outside the leader.

The pace wasn't set at an extremely high level, which was favorable for the winner.

Leader Don Fanucci Zet was beaten already with a quarter of a mile to go and even if Vivid Wise As finished strongly as second, the victory became very safe for Fabrice Souloy's horse.

Ampa Mede SM came home in a mile rate of 1:53 and the Italian success in the race was completed by Vivid Wise As' runner up performance. Philippe Allaire trained Hohnneck finished third.

The 4-year-olds battled in Saturday's (Feb. 11) \$125,000 Prix Ephrem Houel at Vincennes and the race became a spectacular show with the horses from positions sixth and seventh over fought for the win.

Juninho Dry, who was the race's second choice, made a break immediately behind the gate and opened up for two other strong "J-horses" in the French 4-years-old crop. Joyner Sport attacked from sixth over in the last turn and behind him, Thierry Duvaldestin's **Juliet Papa Bravo** (Ready Cash) followed. Driver Clément Duvaldestin had plenty of power as the field turned for home. Juliet Papa Bravo flew in the stretch after Joyner Sport gained advantage of the race approaching the wire. But Juliet Papa Bravo put his nose first at the line. The mile rate over 1.3 miles was 1:54.4.

Only seven 5-year-old trotters gathered when Sunday's (Feb. 12) \$125,000 Prix Ovide Moulinet was on the menu at Vincennes, but some of the best trotters in the crop tried to capture the trophy, and Prix d'Amérique favorite **Idao de Tillard** was one of them. Clément Duvaldestin hit the lead at an early stage and got toughest opponent Italiano Vero on the outside. The fitful pace in the race didn't bother the leading favorite Idao de Tillard and on the stretch, Duvaldestin let his horse use the great capacity that he possesses. The win became safe in a mile rate of 2:00.2 over 1.6 miles and it was probably a smart move to remove Idao de Tillard from the entries list in Prix de France the same day.

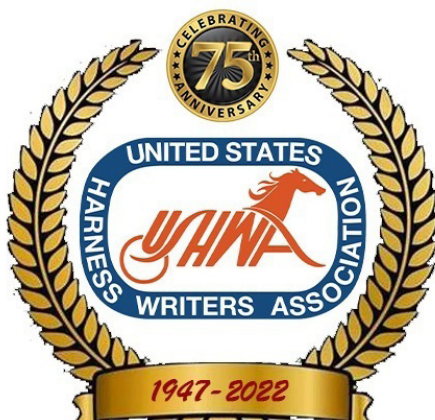

Jordan Ross to represent the United States in World Driving Championship

The thought of representing the U.S. in August's **World Driving Championship** (WDC) already has kept Jordan Ross awake at night. But in the best possible way.

Ross, a 25-year-old Tennessee native who enjoyed a breakout season on the Indiana circuit in 2022, has been selected by the U.S. Trotting Association to wear the Stars and Stripes in this year's WDC. The event, conducted since 1970, will bring together a dozen drivers to compete in 20 races at four different tracks in three different countries — The Netherlands, Germany, and Belgium — Aug. 13-18.

"Jordan Ross is a coming-to-the-top driver who grew up around horses in Tennessee and is making a name for himself in the Midwest, earning over \$1.6 million in 2022," said U.S. Trotting Association president Russell Williams. "He will represent the United States brilliantly at this world event."

Ross will follow in the footsteps of recent U.S. reps Yannick Gingras, Marcus Miller, and Tim Tetrick in the competition. Gingras finished second in Sweden in 2019 while Miller was third in Canada in 2017 and Tetrick was third in Australia in 2015. The last U.S. driver to win the WDC was Dave Magee in 1995.

"I watched some of the races when those guys were in it, and I never thought in a million years that I would be going to it," Ross said. "The night I found out I stayed up late just thinking about it. I watched a couple races from over there, just trying to see what the atmosphere was like."

"Representing the U.S., that's amazing. It's very exciting, and I'm honored to get the chance. The main thing is to stay focused, not get too far ahead of myself. Just stay hard at it and try to get better each and every day."

Ross, who got his first driving win in 2016, entered last year with a total of 131 victories in 1,018 starts and \$884,213 in purses. In 2022, he surpassed not only his best previous campaign, but his overall career figures by posting 153 triumphs and \$1.62 million in purses while driving in nearly the same number of prior races: 1,084.

His 83 wins at Harrah's Hoosier Park put him seventh in the driver standings and represented a 361-per cent increase over

his 18 victories at the Indiana oval in 2021. In addition, Ross finished second in wins and purses last year on the Indiana fairs circuit, with 48 triumphs and \$153,354 in money.

"It happened so quickly, it took a while to sink in," Ross said about his rapid ascent. "I had fun driving at the fairs. It was a blast. Some of the people I drove for at the fairs, I did OK with their horses and then they let me drive a little more for them at Hoosier."

"It's really a confidence thing. Sometimes, you can be at a very high point if you have a good week, and sometimes you can be at a very low point if you have a bad week. Balancing everything is the key. The main thing is to go out there and do the best I

can with the horses I get to drive."

Ross was introduced to harness racing by his grandfather, Graham, who trained a stable of 15 to 20 horses that raced primarily at the Illinois fairs. Ross was hanging around his grandfather's barn at an early age and became immersed in the business. Ross began working for Robert Taylor, one of his grandfather's friends, in 2015.

"I think I first started going to the barn when I was 4 or 5," Ross said. "From there, I learned how to clean stalls, learned how to harness, the right way to do stuff. It's something I love doing. I love being around horses. You can see the transition from them being babies to becoming racehorses and then from 2 to 3 seeing how their progress goes. From kind of being green to being good, smart racehorses."

This year, Ross has been driving at Miami Valley Raceway, where he has 14 wins. He will return to Hoosier Park when it opens its 2023 season on March 24. When he has time, he will prepare to take on the world. Rick Ebbinge, from The Netherlands, is the defending WDC titleholder.

"I'll watch as many races as I can from over there and try to see the style of racing," Ross said. "It's a different atmosphere. And I'll watch the other drivers (in the WDC) to see their driving styles. I'll take some notes. I've got a little time to prepare."

He also has time to prepare for new languages, cuisines, and cultures.

"I'll get to see parts of the world that I might not otherwise get to visit," Ross said. "I'll have to see if I can pick up all the different languages. I'm not too picky (when it comes to food). I don't mind trying new things. As long as it tastes good, I don't mind trying it."

"It will be a very exciting experience."

Jim Morrill Jr. gets career win 8,000 at Batavia Downs

Driver Jim Morrill Jr. achieved another major milestone in his stellar career at Batavia Downs on Monday (Feb.13) when he drove Sportskeeper (\$4.70) to an easy gate to wire, 1:56.1 victory in the seventh race to achieve his 8,000th lifetime win in the sulky. Morrill would also win with Gorgeous View (1:58.3, \$7.00) and Silver Buckeye (2:00.2, \$8.40) for the hat trick to put an exclamation mark on his landmark day.

At the end of business Monday, Morrill had 42,173 starts with 8,002 wins, 6,594 seconds and 5,413 thirds and \$112,388,888 in earnings for his tenure in the sport. That purse total puts him 21st on the all-time earnings list among all drivers in North America. So far in 2023 Morrill has a UDR of .496 and sits in second among all drivers in North America with less than 300 starts so far this year. And at the current Batavia Downs meet, Morrill is the leading UDR driver (.496) and sits second for wins (22) and earnings (\$135,240).

Morrill reached 7,500 wins just two years and three months ago in 2020 at Batavia and it only took him 1,850 starts to get those next 500 wins.

A native of Methuen, MA, Morrill had aspirations of playing in the National Hockey League after being a junior hockey star prior to his career in harness racing, and those who know him

would attest he was good enough to achieve that goal. But Morrill chose to follow in his father's footsteps and made his first driving start at Foxboro Park in 1984. The family's operation eventually moved to Rosecroft Raceway where Morrill began getting many catch drives and soon found himself in high demand. In 1990 Morrill went to New York and started driving for Ray Schnittker and George Anthony at Yonkers Raceway and with all the success he had there, decided that move would be long term.

During his time competing on the Metropolitan circuit, Morrill recalled his most memorable race as being the 2004 Meadowlands Pace where Holborn Hanover was a 58-1 upset winner in 1:49 to equal the stakes mark. Among his other notable wins are three Breeders Crown finals with See You At Peelers, Won The West and Yellow Diamond and the 2012 Yonkers Trot with Archangel.

After 15 years of driving at the highest level of competition, Morrill left the big city in 2005 and relocated his family and business to western New York. And since arriving on the scene there he has not only been at the very top of the local driver colony, but also became a dominant force in the New York Sire Stakes.

In 2006 at Batavia Downs, Morrill set the all-time driving standard with 177 wins and a UDR of .537 for one meet. He also co-holds the track mark for most driving wins on one card (seven) and just last year, became the first driver to ever surpass \$1 million in purse earnings in a single season at Batavia Downs.

Randy Bendis collects 4,000th training win

Randy Bendis notched career training win 4,000 when Muscle Up The Gold won Wednesday's (Feb. 15) 11th race at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows. Bendis ranks eighth on the all-time win list for trainers.

Bendis, 63, grew up not far from The Meadows and has been based there throughout his career. A football player in high school, Bendis was introduced to harness racing as a fan and saw a connection between the two activities.

"I couldn't see myself going on to college," Bendis said. "This was a way of staying involved in athletics without having to go to college."

While in high school, he began grooming for Linden Creek Farm and trainer Allen Saul, among others, receiving special

dispensation from his school to work in the mornings and attend classes each afternoon.

He opened his stable in the late 1970s and initially was a trainer-driver, collecting 269 wins and earning more than \$500,000 in purses as a driver. But he soon abandoned that pursuit.

"Driving and training made me nuts," Bendis said. "I'd get very down on myself. I thought, 'I drive pretty good, but I don't do it great. If I intend to stick with this, I'd better get somebody great to drive.' Now I can blame other people instead of blaming myself. And I don't take the losses as hard. As you get older, you realize racing is not life and death because you experience life and death."

Although his official win total now is 4,000, the actual figure is higher because the United States Trotting Association began compiling and archiving trainer statistics in 1991, well after Bendis launched his career. Using old race programs, retired track announcer Roger Huston determined that Bendis collected 276 wins at The Meadows that aren't included in his official win total.

"It's a shame we can't tell how many training wins Howard Beissinger or George Sholtz had," Bendis said. "We're talking about people like Delvin Miller and Billy Haughton. But I'm past worrying about my total. The only thing that would bother me is if they said they wanted to name a race for me because that would mean I'd died."

Among his favorite horses, Bendis cites Georgia Pacific, who won a 2004 elimination of the Delvin Miller Adios Pace for the Orchids, and Ultimate Goal, who captured a 1992 Breeders Crown elimination for freshman filly trotters and finished third in the Hambletonian Oaks the following year.

"After that, I had people knocking on my door," Bendis said.

Bendis is gratified by his career-long success at The Meadows, where he's achieved 19 seasons with at least 100 wins; his horses have earned more than \$32 million in purses.

"I've had a lot of good raceway horses," Bendis said. "I've had owners who have given me the opportunity to train a lot of good hard-knockers; that's what my barn has been. Probably what I'm most proud of is being a consistent force at The Meadows."

Bendis attributes much of that success to Dave Teed, his longtime second trainer.

"Believe me, he's the heart and soul of our operations," Bendis said. "I send him on impossible missions: go to Northfield tonight in the snow and make sure you're back in the barn at 7. And he is. He's been like a brother to me."

One goal has eluded Bendis – winning the Adios – but he may have a shot at the orchids this year with American Fling, a 2022 New York Sires Stakes freshman champion.

"I'm a local guy," Bendis said, "so winning the Adios would be cool."

Class is key to handicapping at BIG M

There are many factors that handicappers use when making their selections at The Meadowlands. Some of the rationales lead to favorites, while others lead to big prices, something Big M players don't mind waiting for, because at the mile oval, they do connect.

In the end, a player needs to find the right balance for them.

First up is class handicapping. The final time is one way to determine which horse is classier than which. If you have a horse whose been finishing fifth or sixth in his last six starts, but the winning time of the race is in the 1:51 range, we can assume with a degree of certainty that this horse is classier than one who's been hitting the board lately in races that have been timed in 1:54 or so.

More sophisticated players can break the final mile times into fractional times, which can lead a player to an obscure horse at big odds.

Some players like to use statistical data that is available in the program to make their selections. It may not be easy to catch a horse at a big price when you play the top drivers and trainers, but they do tend to be a reliable way to go.

If a handicapper plays a horse who's trained by Ron Burke and driven by Yannick Gingras, the expected payout is going to be less than if he uses a less prominent conditioner and pilot, but when one can sniff those out, the reward is usually realized.

When looking at past performances and a handicapper is trying to figure out which horse is classier than another, it's good to have a chart that shows which claiming and conditioned classes are similar, not to mention the relatively new TrackMaster rating system, which has been one of the prominent new ways that race secretaries seed horses to make for competitive fields.

At The Meadowlands, race secretary Scott Warren has made his basic conditions simple to understand. With the help of the old, classified ABC system as a guide, we will illustrate how easy it is to follow the ups and downs of the class ladder at the mile oval.

AA = Marquee 3YO and 3YO & Up stakes

A1 = Free For All/Invitational

A2 = Non-winners of \$20,000 last five starts or Preferred

A3 = Non-winners of \$15,000 L5 or TrackMaster 90

B1 = Non-winners of \$10,000 L5 or TM 86

B2 = Non-winners of \$7,500 L5 or TM 83

B3 = Non-winners of \$5,000 L5 or TM 80

C1 = Non-winners of \$3,000 L5 or TM 77

C2 = TM 74

"The chart shows the various levels broken down into their simplest form," said chief operating officer/general manager

Jason Settlemoir. "The (above) chart is based on horses currently racing at The Meadowlands and how they perform in these events. The higher the class, the faster the competition. The end result is races that are the most competitive in the harness game, which yield a low percentage of winning favorites that are comparable to the top Thoroughbred tracks in North America.

"As we head into summer, some of these classes get much tougher and may need adjusting. Right now, a \$10,000 claimer would be similar to a non-winners of \$3,000 or TrackMaster 77. This level stays fairly consistent."

On the other hand, some adjustments need to be made when doping out races with younger horses in the non-winners of "x" amount of races. In the winter, a non-winners of four is a middle condition, but as we move into summer, that condition becomes loaded with horses that will soon be racing at the top levels.

These are the ever-changing dynamics of racing that create the parimutuel puzzles that everyone loves to try and figure out to get paid every Friday and Saturday night.

In the trot, the 4-year-old Crescent Fashion mare Crescent Beauty finished the year with three victories to bring her 2022 total to 16, the joint leader in victories among North American sophomore diamond-gaiters. If she is to extend her win streak, Crescent Beauty will have to do it against tougher foes and from post seven in an eight-horse field for driver Anthony Napolitano, trainer Lance Hudson, and owner William Hartt.

In the pace, the main battle may be between the Sweet Lou gelding Phoenix Of Fluzzy (post four of eight, driver Simon Allard, and trainer Ron Burke, last year's winningest local conditioner), who has three wins in his last four starts at The Meadowlands and the Captaintreacherous gelding Mind Hunter (post six, driver George Napolitano Jr.), who is perfect in four starts since hooking up with trainer Per Engblom, including a 1:49.3 victory last time out.

Fans looking for sharp stables in the early season noted that trainers Deborah Daguet and Darren Taneyhill each sent out a pair of winners; also doubling on the sulky side were Braxten Boyd, defending driver champion Matt Kakaley and Marcus Miller.
