Life lessons from the wholly original, deeply generous Charlie Juravinski

The former owner of Flamboro Downs died Wednesday at the age of 92, but not before becoming one of the biggest philanthropists in Canadian history.

It would be easy enough to remember Charlie Juravinski for the flamboyant clothes, his deep tan or the nicotine-thick, no-BS bossman's bark that came with telling you exactly how it is. In that way, there was a certain J. Jonah Jameson quality to the man.

It would also be appropriate to remember Juravinski's many passions: his deep, 65-year romance with his wife Margaret at the top of a list of loves that included horses and dogs and Flamboro Downs, the Hamilton racetrack he founded with principal partners Ray Connell and John Grant and proudly ran like the commander of a battleship. On Juravinski's ship, no quarter was given to his rivals at the Ontario Jockey Club or horsepeople that disagreed with how things should be run. Yet, he also ensured everything was spic and span with not a thing out of place.

On the latter, I can remember a day spent with Juravinski, 25 years ago now, when he detoured to pick up the tiniest piece of garbage on a trip through the Flamboro grandstand and even quickly produced a dust buster from beside his desk to whisk away the slightest speck of cigarette ash that had the audacity to evade his ashtray.

For a man born the day the stock market crashed in 1929 and North America was plunged into the Great Depression, the sting of poverty never completely faded.

"I'm still in my heart of hearts as cheap now as I was when we were in the height of the Depression," he once told me.

Yet, the Depression also taught him to work hard and formed his fastidiousness for taking care of the things he loved.

The people of Hamilton know this best.

Juravinski died Wednesday at the age of 92, but not before donating some \$60 million to a variety of health care initiatives in Hamilton and establishing a \$100 million endowment fund that will long provide funding to care for those that took care of him as former customers at Flamboro Downs.

"All of those people supported us. They came to the track. They put the money in our pocket, in our staff's pocket," he once told me just before being inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame as a builder. "We decided, 'What better way is there to give back and touch their lives?'"

Juravinski and his partners opened Flamboro Downs in April of 1975. The track cost \$5 million to build. The idea was to get the cash flowing as quickly as possible. When Flamboro opened, boy did it flow. Opening night was a smashing success.

"We caused a traffic jam on #5 highway and #6 highway. You couldn't move in the grandstand... It was cheek-by-jowl. We had to lock the door because you couldn't let anybody else in. There was no room to move," Juravinski said.

He sold Flamboro Downs to Magna Entertainment in 2002 for \$72 million (the track is now owned by the Great Canadian Gaming Corporation). Long after he sold the track, Juravinski still showed up at the door to greet customers on Confederation Cup night and present the trophy as if he still owned the joint. No one was about to tell Charlie Juravinski any differently.

This was the same man that loudly proclaimed that he would roll in the mud if his Georgina Seelster won an Ontario Sires Stakes event at Flamboro in 1988 and then followed through – lime green suit and all – when she did. Despite his reputation as a tough guy, Juravinski loved to have a good time.

Juravinski was connected to a number of outstanding horses, including two Hall of Famers – Matts Scooter and his beloved homebred mare Ellamony.

"The thing that destroyed me as far as horse ownership was when we had to put Ellamony down," he once told me. "She was going to be the broodmare of all broodmares, as far as we were concerned."

For many years after Ellamony was inducted into the Canadian

Hall of Fame in 1998, Charlie wore her ring until he got his own.

But his greatest achievement was devoting his life to extreme philanthropy after selling Flamboro Downs.

Just the day before his death, and in the spirit of Valentine's Day, he and Margaret announced a \$5.1 million donation toward health care in the city through the Juravinski Research Institute.

Many years before, when he announced his first multi-million-dollar donation to Hamilton health care, Juravinski called the press to Flamboro to implore the horse racing industry to follow suit as a gesture to thank the people of the province that gifted the industry the lucrative Slots at Racetracks Program (SARP). His logic: no politician would dare cut a program if the industry was using some of the proceeds to support health care.

Naturally, the industry ignored his advice – as it was often wont to do – and SARP is just a distant, fading memory.

But I hope Charlie Juravinski won't be. While his death has left the world a lot less colorful, his extreme generosity and unmatched flair for life should be a constant model for us all.

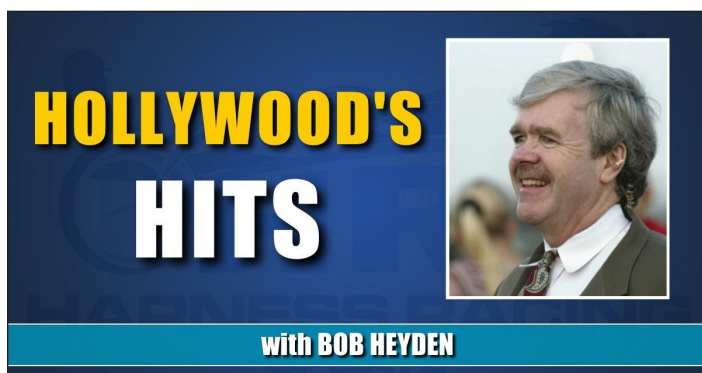

Top 20 all-time horses not named Horse of the Year

My opinion. In descending order.

20. Red Bow Tie. The richest horse ever to race in both the Meadowlands Pace and the North America Cup, not get a dime-and still make \$2.8 million. A fabulous older pacer, he won the Driscoll (then changed to the William Haughton), dominating the best older pacers in the world.

19. Darlins Delight. Banked \$2.9 million and somehow never won a Breeders Crown. Just everything else. Grew up at White Birch Farm with her partner in crime My Little Dragon, who won three of those Crowns.

18. Mister Big. The world's first \$4 million pacing stallion. He was a star early on but not yet a superstar. That came under the tutelage of Virgil Morgan, Jr. as he reached his prime and maintained it later in his career.

17. Magician. The winner of the first \$1 million Breeders Crown race in 2000, banked \$3.5 million in his fabulous career, nearly all of it after 3. He was an enigma on the New York Sires Stakes scene, simply not consistent as a youngster. Once he matured, Earl Cruise then campaigned the best trotter in the world for a couple of years, winning the illustrious Su Mac Lad 3 straight times from 2000-2002.

16. Fools Goal. Well over \$3 million lifetime. You could make a case – and a good one – that this back-to-back Breeders Crown winner – the richest ever Breeders Crown performer at \$800,000 – was the best trotter of his time. That is when he stayed trotting. Twenty-eight career wins, 27 career breaks. Oh my.

15. Varenne. I know I know, he raced here just twice in 2001. That year he was third to Bunny Lake and Syrinx Hanover in the HOY balloting. But his first ever start here might just be the best trotting mile of the century – a 1:51.1 world record in the 2001 Breeders Crown. By open lengths as he pleased against a

strong group of the very best in all of North America. New track record at the Meadowlands. Maybe the most significant stat on him is this: he beat 623 horses in his career.

14. Adios Harry. The 1955-1956 HOY runner-up to Scott Frost both times. Nobody remembers the name much these days, but Luther Lyons made the cover of Sports Illustrated with Adios Harry in July, 1956. The very first of four times the sport was so celebrated.

13. Windsongs Legacy. The 2004 Triple Crown winner who passed on racing in the Breeders Crown, thus costing him a very real shot at HOY. As it turned out, he was second to Rainbow Blue 119 votes to 98. He also sired Chapter Seven, who sired Walner, who sired both divisional winners in his first crop in 2021.

12. Entry of Tarport Hap/Silk Stockings. They were born the same year (1972) from the first crop of Most Happy Fella. They dominated the NYSS in tandem and didn't miss a step after that. They finished with \$5G of each other in lifetime earnings (just under \$700,000 each) Silk Stockings lost HOY to Savoir in the closest ever ballot in 1975: 52-49. Tarport Hap was on her way in 1977 to a season for the ages, then fate stepped in and she died on the track on March 12 after eight wins against male competition. She remains the only division winner ever not to take a single step onto the track in the spring-summer or fall of their award winning season (1977).

11. Overcall in 1969 was a perfect 21-for-21 at age 6. A beyond belief free-for-all season for Del Insko. But that same year, Nevele Pride was lowering two treasured records – the half-mile trotting mark and the all-time one: 1:56.4 and 1:54.4. So, Overcall had to settle for second to the great Nevele Pride in the final tally. There was even one voter-obviously trying to call attention to him/herself who did not vote for Overcall as Older Pacer Of The Year. The votes were 204-1 with WW Smith getting that lone vote.

10. Lucky Jim in 2009 had a million-dollar season in the Andy/Julie Miller barn. As a 4-year-old he was 17-for-18 on the year, third in one race in Canada where he was all but wiped out of contention early. But, Muscle Hill was running the table that season and nobody was derailing him in the HOY tally.

9. Cardigan Bay, the first Down Under horse to be in the top five in the balloting. He won his division in a tie with Race Time in 1965 (Older Pacer) and then won it outright the year he became the first \$1 million standardbred in 1968. In totality, from coming here from New Zealand in 1964, he made a huge impression but never was able to tell the two-headed monster known as Bret Hanover/Nevele Pride to move aside.

8. Rambling Willie, “The Horse That God Loved” was never HOY but always in the hunt. He is the only \$2 million winner lifetime without ever having a \$400,000 or better single year (\$397,000 his best). Twice he was the all-time leader – Niatross in between – and was as good a story as the sport has ever seen coming from the most humble of beginnings.

7. Western Hanover was likely shorted of between \$500-750G on the track due to bad luck. Most notably his being wiped out in 1992 in the \$1 million Meadowlands Pace and then losing a nostril – and the Triple Crown – in the Jug that year (to Fake Left). Somehow, despite perennially leading North America in earnings, he never did sire a HOY, either.

6. Jennas Beach Boy. The only pacer to win three Breeders Crowns in a row. The only pacer to be named 3YOCP of the year without taking a single step onto the track the summer of his award-winning season (1995). From the first crop of HOY Beach Towel, the 1990 winner. Jenna bumped into Cams Card Shark in 1994 and then a couple of standout sophomore trotting ladies C R Kay Suzie (1995 HOY) and then Continentalvictory (1996 HOY).

5. Presidential Ball – \$3 million plus. The only member of the \$3 million pacing club to hit the board in each Triple Crown race. But sometimes it doesn't matter how good you are if there are a couple of bearcats in your graduation class such as Riyadh and Life Sign. They were all sophomores in 1993.

4. Art Major. You will hear his name on HOY night as he is the sire of this year's winner Test Of Faith. His second HOY in seven

years (J K She'salady in 2014). On the racetrack, a bonafide star. A stablemate to McArdle early on from Aug. 1, 2002 to the end of 2003 he was the richest horse in the sport and the horse to beat each and every time out. In 2002, Real Desire got the nod and in 2003, Art Major bumped into the very last pacer to win a Triple Crown who then parlayed that into year-end honors – No Pan Intended.

3. Eternal Camnation. An all-star from day one. She won her division at age 2, 4, 5 and 6. She remains the richest pacing female ever. From the final crop of Cam Fella, his richest performer and that is saying plenty. Circumstances denied her any HOY trophy.


2. Foiled Again. A shame this warrior supreme couldn't get that honor. At 2-3 remember he was just ordinary – 7-for-27 good for \$57,000. He then blossomed like no other from early summer at 4 (with Ron Burke) for the remainder of his career amassing a mind-boggling \$7.6 million. Far, far ahead of anyone else.

1. Peace Corps. OMG. Five years on the track, five division titles 1988-1992. That includes just a single North American race in 1992, when she captured her fourth Breeders Crown. That has not been equaled in the three decades since.

Adrienne Hall responds to Russell Williams

In response to (USTA president Russell Williams') comments about me in the HRU ([2022-02-13 Feedback](#)), I have the following to say:

Russell Williams is veering from the facts and being disingenuous regarding the USTA's true motives. The USTA did not make the decision to take my membership based on my testimony. T.C. Lane, CEO of the USTA, acknowledged to my attorney that it was done prior to my transcript being available and occurred after reading the one initial media report. Unlike the NJRC who waited to receive context from myself and discuss the matter, the USTA was looking for a quick press release and nothing more when they revoked my membership. I've not held back once from speaking with any organization looking to learn more of the facts. The USTA's action and silence towards me feels as if it is a "Punish the source" mentality instead of about cleaning up the game.

I did not have a "history" of using Performance Enhancing Drugs. In fact, this was my very first year in the harness business. If he thinks I walked into the barn knowing anything about drugs or pre-racing, guess again. He should be more concerned and utterly embarrassed that in the backyard of the USTA headquarters, one of the biggest dealers of illegal drugs was allowed free rein of the Ohio horses and trainers for years before the Feds stepped in to stop him. If anyone at his organization were doing their job, the Government, 5 Stones, Jockey Club, and Jeff Gural would not have had to do it for them. No matter how many times he wants to state as fact that I reached out to Fishman solely to acquire PEDS, it doesn't mean it is true. Testimony and text messages put into evidence clearly show that I innocently reached out to Fishman to perform a lameness exam and to be my horses' primary vet in FL. Other text messages brought in as evidence between Fishman and Gianelli show them discussing me as being "Not very knowledgeable". I was naïve.

In my testimony I did say that it was my understanding that had I been caught administering anything to my horses, I could potentially be in big trouble. What Russell was not privy to were the conversations that I had with the Federal Prosecutors and the FBI about this and they were hopeful that any Governing body of a sport would be inclined to look more at the positives from my cooperation as opposed to focusing solely on the admissions I made.

Russell mentions BB3, TB7, etc..as some form of "Gotcha" but can he tell me what they are? Has anyone had a positive test for these things? I did not want Epogen or to hurt my horses and I made that abundantly clear. What may be the biggest irony here is that while these drugs are untestable on race day and he uses them as examples of my cheating, he and the USTA have fought HISA and its desire to implement comprehensive Out-of Competition Testing that might very well have an impact on these substances ability to be used; all while simultaneously touting how clean the industry's race day testing results are as a way to laughably argue against the need for HISA.

While what I did was wrong and I owned up to it despite never being indicted and working for two years with the Feds with no guarantees of the outcome, the USTA and Russell Williams' response to the criminal cases and my situation only goes to show where the real problem in harness racing lay.

Whether it be the USTA turning a blind eye to the thousands of horses who are ending up in kill pens, moving to eliminate Freezebrands to make the horses unidentifiable, or fighting Congress, WHOA, HISA, The Jockey Club, Breeders' Cup, Jeff Gural, and USADA's efforts to clean up the sport, their arrogance and disregard for the issues in racing is telling. An organization that ignores their own Board Member, Joe Faraldo's, ties to indicted trainers, ignores the Fishman client list that became public

recently, pushes back on everyone from Congress to Aftercare entities, while attacking a trainer with two horses in her care as the problem, is either arrogant, clueless, crooked, a part of the bigger problem, or probably all of the above.

The truth is, my situation is meaningless in the scope of the problems in racing, but they are using it to take the heat off of themselves and to appease the mob on social media (who before my testimony had them in their crosshairs). For the president of any organization seeking credibility to deem my admitted mental health struggles during this situation as "entertaining" pretty much says it all. It's at best a diversion, a redirect, and childish while at the same time making clear he does not have the horses, industry, or industry participants best interests at heart.

I made a mistake. I owned up to that mistake. I did so willingly and would do it again even now knowing that it has resulted in what is probably my last race in the Standardbred Industry. What I won't own or accept is the fact that a monopolistic entity and its leadership that is solely interested in protecting their own personal interests is going to set the narrative and lie their way towards making the public believe they give a damn.

Young drivers at The Big M have less time to shine

The clock is ticking for young drivers to make a mark at The Meadowlands.

Winter is usually the time when most of the top drivers take a break, opening the door for newer faces to be seen.

For example, on New Year's Eve 2021, Scott Zeron was the only Big M fall meet top-10 driver competing.

Meadowlands race secretary Scott Warren has noticed more young drivers than usual racing this winter.

"Opportunities open up in the winter time when a lot of the regular guys are not around," said Warren. "That's how the possible next superstar of the business is created. If they get the right drive, it can lead to a stakes drive for one of them. You never know."

Of the six fresh faces currently competing, Luke Hanners, 21, is the senior member of the group even though Jack Pelling, 26, is older. Hanners has more on-track experience since Pelling only started racing in 2020.

"Right now, with a couple of the drivers gone, it makes it a little easier, but it's not easy," said Hanners, who already has three wins at The Big M this year.

Hanners drives semi-regularly for both Jennifer Bongiorno and Edwin Quevedo.

"I liked the way he drove at Freehold, so I gave him the opportunity to drive my horses [at The Meadowlands]," said Quevedo of Hanners. "He's good with a lazy horse."

Quevedo also uses Tyler Miller, 24, and in 2021, 16 of Miller's 19 Big M wins were for Quevedo.

"[Tyler's] done good for me," said Quevedo. "He's young and young guys need a chance to drive horses.

"Everybody needs a chance and when I see these guys are available, why not give them a chance to drive a horse? If people see them drive more horses, they will get more chances."

In addition to Hanners, Miller and Pelling, Brett Beckwith, 19, Jacob Cutting, 21, and Trae Porter, 20, are also trying to pick up drives and get noticed.

"Usually, the winter months help a lot of young guys get experience," said Beckwith. "It's definitely an appreciated opportunity during the winter months to go there and race because it is the mecca of harness racing per se."

Beckwith's first Big M win came on Dec. 2, 2021, and he already has one in 2022.

"I'm hoping to just get my name out there and keep grinding," said Beckwith. "I remember Aaron Merriman saying that his biggest thing is if someone puts him down, they know he's going to be there. And I've never called off a drive in my life and I don't plan on it unless I'm on my deathbed sick and can't move. But if someone lists me down and it's one drive three or four hours away, I'm going to be there."

Pelling got his first Big M win last week and values the experience of racing at such a revered place.

"I feel like The Meadowlands is already the most competitive place probably to get drives just because of the place that it is, but for a young driver, it must be the hardest place at any time," said Pelling.

Cutting only started competing at The Big M on Jan. 22, 2022 and with just 16 starts doesn't have a win. Porter also has not found the winner's circle yet this year in 17 starts. However, in 2021, he had 12 starts with one win, two seconds and two thirds and that win came on New Year's Eve.

There is perhaps more of a sense of urgency this year to make a mark, since drivers are now required to race at The Meadowlands consistently starting on March 4 in order to drive during the Championship Meet. With all the top drivers coming back, in some cases, at least a month earlier than usual, there is less time this year for young drivers to be seen on the world's biggest stage.

Since The Meadowlands is looking to get their product on TV more often this year, they want consistency when it comes to who is driving.

However, it should be noted that on the aforementioned Dec. 31 card, The Meadowlands handled over \$2.9 million, the highest of the fall meet for a non-stakes night. On that night, in addition to Porter, Beckwith and Hanners also made a trip to the winner's circle.

Even though they did not get a win, Miller and Pelling also drove on New Year's Eve.

"I guess it kind of makes you realize, in a way, that the opportunity is there," said Pelling. "It's not an unreachable task of being that driver at The Meadowlands. So, it gives everyone a taste of that.

"I feel like sometimes at Freehold, you can ride the rail and use the track to your advantage, but at The Meadowlands, it's a different game that you've got to learn. And I feel like it's more just about the horse power and having to be in the right spot. It's something to wrap my head around for sure."

Hanners, who had his first and second Big M wins on the same night in June 2021, has some advice for his fellow young guns.

"Be patient and enjoy it and don't stress about it because it's a pleasure just to be able to drive there," said Hanners.

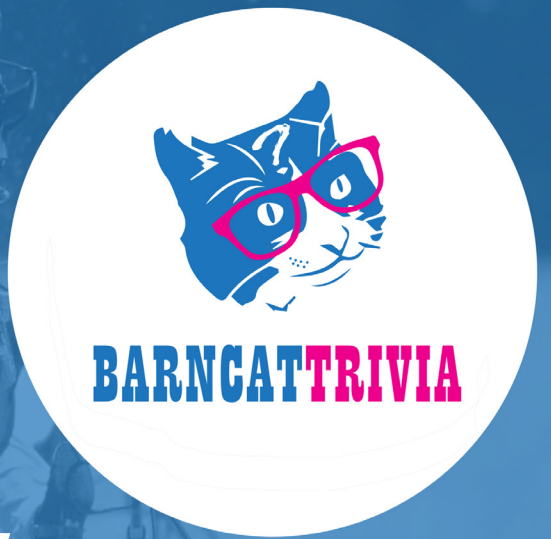
Beckwith said he feels like he is 19 going on 40 and wants everything to happen at lightning speed, but understands what Hanners is saying.

"Eventually, I would like to make it there to race consistently and know that when I pull up the entries that I'm going to see my name there, but it takes time to build up the credibility and clientele of trainers," said Beckwith.

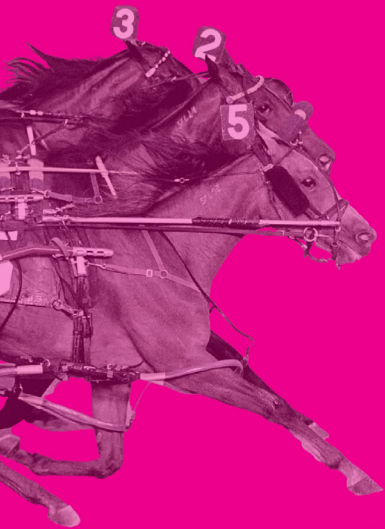

The passion of horsewoman Nicole Di Costanzo

The moment was even better than Nicole Di Costanzo had envisioned.

It was a dream she held for over eight years, the one where she would cross the wire first and make her way to the winner's circle at a standardbred racetrack in her home state of New Jersey.

On the night of Jan. 7, 2022 at The Meadowlands, the driver in black, white and grey felt she had a good shot of seeing that dream become a reality.

She still felt that way after the starter car sped away and Rockabilly Charm, a well-traveled 7-year-old son of Rock N Roll Heaven, got away ninth.

"There were 10 horses and we got away second-last. I knew he'd be good that night, but I didn't quite estimate how good he'd be."

Sent off at 9-1, Rockabilly Charm, bred by Glenview Livestock Ltd., and owned by Victoria D'Alessandro, was making his 107th

career start.

Di Costanzo, who had already won several races as a trainer, was chasing her milestone victory in the race bike in the GSY Series amateur race.

Fifth and rolling at the half, the duo was picking up steam and picking off rivals with nearly every stride, continuing their drive to the front around the turn.

"When I pulled him out, he just never stopped coming. As soon as I had tipped him three-deep, I knew he was going to keep going."

And that's just what the hard-trying gelding managed to do.

At the wire, Rockabilly Charm eked out a head score in a time of 1:55.4.

"It was unbelievable. You wait so long for a moment like that and then it happens. It's a bit of a shock. You try and put it all together in your mind and it's really kind of surreal. I've always pictured that day in my head, but when you're standing there in the winner's circle, there's nothing else in your mind but just happiness."

Di Costanzo had another reason to smile again one week later when she teamed with Rockabilly Charm to win at Freehold.

"That feeling you get when you win is something you never get tired of."

Especially for someone who still finds it hard to believe how she wound up in the harness racing industry.

"I never thought my life would pan out this way. I really do have zero background in racing. I was never really that interested. My grandfather, he owned thoroughbreds, but I didn't really have that much interest in any of it. Basically, I knew it the moment I first sat behind a horse. I was about 15 and I knew from that day on that I wanted to do it. I bought my first horse, Steady Pulse, eight years ago and I still have him today. I was interested in owning, but I hadn't really thought about being

a trainer at that point. I got my first set of colors when I was 16 and I started warming up my own horses and a couple for some other people. I started to really like it and I knew I had to go out and get my trainer's license."

In 2018, her rookie season as a trainer, Di Costanzo, who would launch her driving life one year later, posted four wins and 17 top-three finishes from 70 starts.

After putting up two wins in each of the next two campaigns, she enjoyed a banner year in 2021, one in which she recorded 15 wins in 120 starts and \$257,264 in purse earnings, both career-best numbers.

A majority of her success came at Yonkers Raceway, where she won 10 times and had her pacer Uptown Funk race in the open handicap.

Currently, she has six horses in her stable.

"I've been going to the barn since I was 15 and I can remember the days when I would wake my mom up at 5:30 in the morning and say, 'Time to get up... we have to go to the barn! I have to see my horse.' Once I had him [Steady Pulse], and had a reason to be there every day, I never looked back and thought I wanted to be doing anything else."

These days, Di Costanzo has plenty more to look forward to.

The drive to succeed, she noted, has never been stronger.

"I really want to keep driving. I really do enjoy it. I don't get many drives, but when I do, it's something I just love. Eventually, I'd like to get a few of my own to start driving. I want to keep training and get up to somewhere between 10-15 horses. The best part of being a trainer is watching them every week."

Win, top four or off the board, Di Costanzo still sports a wide smile when she heads home after the races are over.

"Even if they don't do well, I still have a reason to be happy. I don't ever get down on myself if I have a bad week because I get to come to the barn the next day and realize they are more horses and I actually got this far."

Di Costanzo makes the most of her time away from the racetrack.

Whenever she's afforded the opportunity, travelling tops her list.

"I have made it a point to enjoy life outside of racing. I commit to turning my horses out two times a year for a week or 10 days and go on vacation. I can't get on a plane fast enough. I want to travel the world. I've been to Denmark, Sweden, Mexico, Jamaica and a lot of places in Florida."

Her trip to Sweden was the perfect marriage between exploring a new place and spending time with horses.

"When I was there, I actually got to train horses. I went to Johan Untersteiner's barn, and I got to sit behind horses for him. That was an amazing experience. I loved it. It was the dead of winter and just freezing. It was pouring rain, but I was out there, all smiles."

It's a familiar look for the young horsewoman who has come a long way in a short time, in a sport that at one time was never on her radar.

Now, she can't imagine being anywhere else.

"I just want to keep on working hard in every aspect of what I do. I love what I do."

It certainly shows.

Matthieu Abrivard drove the Italian-bred trotter who continues to prove his strengths and abilities when shorter distances are offered.

Vivid Wise As claimed the Prix de France in new stakes record mile rate of 1:52.1 after a third over trip. Second over trotter Zacon Gio held strongly as third while Delia du Pommereux showed that her form stepped up one level after a pretty disappointing winter meeting as runner up.

Delia du Pommereux can, and will most likely, be aimed against a title defending race at Åby when Paralympiavet waits later on this spring and it would be a surprise if Vivid Wise As doesn't get an early invitation for Elitloppet. Gocciadoro's horse was runner up at Solvalla 2021 and it seems like the son of Yankee Glide is better than ever this season.

Hooker Berry wins Prix Ovide Moulinet

The \$135,000 Prix Ovide Moulinet for 5-year-olds was held at Vincennes on the Sunday race card and first choice was Philippe Allaire's Hohneck, who was fifth in the Prix d'Amérique. Even when Hohneck was served a perfect trip by driver Francois Lagadeuc, he couldn't defend himself when Jean-Michel Bazire's **Hooker Berry** (Booster Winner) challenged over the stretch.

Hooker Berry has belonged in the top of the French H-crop but lacked a win since late July last year. This time he came home in a strong a mile rate of 1:57.2 over 1.6 miles.

Criterium des Jeunes this Sunday

Paris' winter meeting is not really over yet and the 3-year-old French bred trotters will meet in the first Criterium for the year this Sunday (Feb. 20). The \$225,000 Criterium des Jeunes features 14 horses where Tomas Malmqvist trained filly Jazzy Perrine (Django Riff) is the most merited to date.

To note, there is a generational change in French harness racing regarding breeding and there is a large spread in terms of sires among the 14 contenders.

Meadowlands statement on post time drag experiment

The Meadowlands, in response to customer and horsepeople frustration with the length of the race cards resulting from the post time "drag", has conducted a six-week experiment with reduced time between races and an earlier end to the races.

Unfortunately, with the shorter drag and a reduction in the time between races, handle has declined by 22 per cent since

the experiment began. Although the comparison is somewhat skewed vs 2021, as COVID protocol in Canada had suspended racing at Mohawk during this period and five of the top Meadowlands drivers are currently absent, the cost is simply too great.

Meadowlands GM Jason Settlemoir outlined the plan moving forward, "We had hoped that we could greatly reduce the amount of time the races consume and at least stay close on the handle, as no one here is a fan of the "drag". Unfortunately, that has not been the case.

"So, for the next two weeks we will be "spotting" our races more carefully to avoid going at the same time as a competing signal from a major track. This makes a huge difference to what we handle remotely, but it will sometimes increase the amount of time between races and the "post time drag". The idea is to be able to execute this process while still getting done earlier than we were last year.

"The following two weeks we expect to see the return of several drivers our players associate with Meadowlands racing, which we are hoping will give the handle a bump.

"After those four weeks are finished, we will analyze the result to try and determine if it is the elimination of the post drag or the absence of the drivers that horseplayers have become accustomed to handicapping at The Meadowlands that is more responsible for the decline in handle. Off that analysis, we'll decide just what our format will be for the rest of the year."

SBOANJ and Meadowlands announce new races

The Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey (SBOANJ) and The Meadowlands are pleased to announce new 3-year-old races for trotters sponsored by the SBOANJ that will serve as a lead in to the 2022 New Jersey Sires Stakes (NJSS).

These races will be considered overnights but will be restricted to those horses eligible to the NJSS and will be scheduled for consecutive Fridays, April 22 and April 29.

The new races will be written as New Jersey Sired 3YO trots (written as separate races for C&G and fillies) that are Non Winners of 3 Pari-Mutuel Races or \$50,000 Lifetime.

Should there be too few entered to accommodate separate filly races, they will be combined and the condition would be adjusted to read: Non Winners of 3 (Mares 4) Pari-Mutuel Races or \$50,000 (Fillies \$75,000) Lifetime.

The purse for all races will be \$25,000.

The NJSS dates follow up the next Friday with legs set for May 6 and May 13 and the finals May 27.

Mike Klau, chairman of the SBOANJ Breeders Committee had this observation, "These races sponsored by the SBOANJ will provide more racing opportunities for New Jersey Sired 3-year-old trotters, who have not yet reached their potential. As a lead in to the NJSS, they will have the opportunity to see if they can compete with the best of their generation."

"This is another example of The Meadowlands and the SBOA working together," said Big M GM Jason Settlemyer. "These races will enhance a NJSS program with increased purses for 2022 that, coupled with the brand new \$2 million NJ Classic Series in September, makes the New Jersey program one of the best regional options available."

Virginia Harness Horse Association announces 2021 certified bonus award winners

The Virginia Harness Horse Association announced today that 25 Virginia-certified horses from the 2019 foal crop — the first to be eligible in a new lucrative residency initiative — will share \$200,000 in bonus monies.

A total of 53 horses from that '19 foal crop enrolled in the program, spent a minimum of six months at a registered farm or training center in the Commonwealth, and accumulated points from all their starts in 2021 when they began racing as 2-year-olds. Year-end point totals were tallied and bonus dollars were rewarded proportionately from the \$200,000 pool. Horses that competed in overnight races in Woodstock — at Shenandoah Downs or the Shenandoah County Fair — received double points.

Top bonus earning horse was Jane Dunavant's Big Daddy D, whose \$26,193 award came from \$67,297 of purse money earned. The Dusty Winner gelding captured both the Virginia Breeder's 2-Year-Old Colt Trotting Elimination and Championship in Woodstock this past fall, and was runner up in both Delaware Standardbred Breeder's Fund (DSBF) elimination legs at Dover.

Breeder/owner Glen Dyke's Charlie's Song earned the second largest award, \$23,570, from two wins and a trio of runner-up finishes from seven starts which translated to purse earnings of \$54,460. The Charlie De Vie trotter was runner-up in the \$70,000 Maryland Sire Stakes final at both Rosecroft and Ocean Downs.

KJ Hunter, third best with \$20,096 in bonus monies, collected a piece of the purse in New York Sire Stake competition at Yonkers, Tioga, Monticello, Saratoga and at Buffalo, where he finished second. The Huntsville pacer broke his maiden June 22 at Monticello and in doing so, became the first Virginia-Certified program enrollee to win a race. He is co-owned by Dr. Scott Woogen, Brenda Messenger and Phil Shapiro.

Pam Wagner's Lisa's All In received a \$17,129 bonus from a pair of second and thirds among the filly's nine starts. The Rusty's All In pacer was a runner-up in both Maryland Sire Stake divisional preps at Rosecroft and finished fourth in the \$70,000 final.

Wagner's Maryland-bred trotter, KJ Stolen Diamond, was fifth in the bonus tally rankings with \$14,835. The Anders Bluestone filly amassed \$30,418 in purse winnings courtesy of runner-up finishes in the Virginia Breeders' prep and finals this past fall and a second in the DSBF elimination at Dover.

Rounding out the top 10 bonus earning freshmen were KJ Unreal (\$13,537), Roddy Boy B (\$7,396), Antares Star (\$7,304), First Over (\$7,278) and Cool Breeze (\$6,789).

The 2019 foal crop will compete for another \$200,000 in bonus monies in 2022 when they compete as 3-year-olds. Owners with 2020, 2021 and soon to be 2022 foals enrolled in the program will experience a nice boost in reward monies — each class will vie for \$400,000 in awards in both their 2- and 3-year-old campaigns.

Horsemen around the country with 2021 foals can choose from 30 registered Virginia farms to send their yearlings to in order to participate in the Certified program. Certified farms are as far north as Berryville and as far south as Bristol. Participating horses must complete a six-month residency before they turn two years of age.

The VHHA's incentive program lineup continues to grow as racing opportunities increase at Shenandoah Downs. The 2022 fall pari-mutuel season will increase in length by three weeks, and will extend from Sept. 16 – Nov. 5 pending VRC approval.

Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association to administer Ohio Sire Stakes program

Administration of the Ohio Sires Stakes program is moving to the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association.

Beginning this year, the OHHA will handle all aspects of the top tier stakes program for the Ohio Standardbred Development Committee. Administration includes nominations, promotion, prizes, and publicity.

"It was the opinion of the Standardbred Development Fund that we join our resources to eliminate several duplications of expenditures in the interest of saving as much money as possible to advance our interests in the standardbred industry," said Dick McClelland, chairman of the Standardbred Development Fund. "With this decision, we will have significant savings in our administration and promotional budgets."

With the OHHA already handling administration on the Buckeye Stallion Series and Ohio Fair Racing Conference in-house, the change occurred primarily to streamline the staking process for horsemen in Ohio, and as a cost-saving measure for the program.

Nomination payments are due at the OHHA office by close of business March 15, 2022. If not received by that date the nomination must have a March 15, 2022 (or earlier) United States Postal Service postmark. Metered mail is not a postmark. Envelopes must be stamped with a postal imprint applied by the USPS office that accepted the mail. If the nomination is received after the deadline date, the post mark is after the deadline date, or is missing, the submission is considered late and will be returned.
