Recalling a memorable 1968 Horse of the Year banquet.

Best of luck to all at the Dan Patch Awards Dinner tonight.

I voted for Bettors Wish as Horse of the Year, but if the award goes to Shartin N or perhaps Greenshoe, I wouldn't argue. May the best, or perhaps the most popular horse win.

Regardless, I expect the outcome to be pretty close.

Time for me to reminisce.

My first Horse of the Year banquet was in 1968. It wasn't yet called the Dan Patch Awards dinner.

It was held at the Sheraton Times Square Hotel in midtown Manhattan. It was a beautiful black tie event with all the men dressed in tuxedos and the women dressed in their very finest.

I remember my late wife Marlene was offered a gorgeous mink coat to borrow by one of her relatives in Long Island. She said she felt like a queen. She also looked like one. If not all, then the majority of the women attending were dressed in furs. How things have changed.

Lawrence Sheppard was being installed in the Hall of Fame.

Mr. Sheppard was in very poor health and was unable to attend. He was to pass away shortly thereafter. John Simpson, Sr., his surrogate, was busy in Orlando at Ben White Raceway training his stable with his son John Jr and couldn't get away.

I was asked to attend and accept in Mr. Sheppard's place.

What an honor.

This punk kid, barely wet behind the years being asked to substitute for the greatest breeder and owner of his generation and maybe ever.

What would I do? What would I say?

To be quite honest, I don't recollect what I did say when Stanley Bergstein introduced me.

The Horse of the Year in 1967 was Nevele Pride, the first 2-year-old trotter to ever capture the award. He would then go on to win this honor for the next two years.

Although Hanover Shoe Farms was not Nevele Pride's breeder, I still felt a strong affiliation to him since he was sired by Stars Pride, a Hanover stallion, and was out of a mare by Hoot Mon, also a Hanover stallion.

In addition, although I had not even been at Hanover for a full year, I had developed a very close friendship with Stanley Dancer, Nevele Pride's trainer and driver.

Here's a little background on how Dancer came to purchase Nevele Pride.

Stanley's older brother Harold R Dancer (Joe Bongiorno's great grandfather) had trained Nevele Pride's dam, a mare called Thankful for Mr. & Mrs. Edward Quin, long-time clients of his. In simple terms, she was a witch. Lois Dancer Simpson, Harold's daughter, called her Little Evil. She was mean and nasty and very difficult to get along with.

Nevele Pride's unruly behavior and meanness was come by honestly.

The Quins decided to breed Thankful to Stars Pride. They got a beautiful colt that they named Thankful's Major.

They weren't in a position to train the colt.

They asked Harold if he had an owner who might be interested in buying Thankful's Major. I believe the price they were asking was \$20,000.

He must have been a gorgeous colt, since Harold Dancer was likely the most demanding yearling buyer I've known in a lifetime in the sport.

Unfortunately, the time was before he had Bill Weaver as an owner. If Weaver had been around then, he almost certainly would have become the colt's owner.

If Harold, couldn't get the colt to train, he would recommend him to his brother. Stanley.

I believe it was sight unseen, but knowing that Harold was so particular, Stanley said that he'd buy the colt.

He approached Ben and Julius Slutsky, the owners of the Nevele Hotel, to buy Thankful's Major. They quickly agreed. They changed his name to Nevele Pride.

Down the road, their friend and neighbor Louis Resnick bought an interest in him.

As great a racehorse as Nevele Pride was, he wasn't quite as successful in the stallion ranks. I consider him to have been a good stallion, but not a great one.

Perhaps his influence is greater in Europe than it has been here in North America.

Nevertheless he made great contributions to the sport, both on the racetrack and in the breeding shed.

He was a well deserving recipient of the Horse of the Year honor.





Improving horse racing is as easy as 1-2-3

The sport struggles with an identity crisis. It no longer has the monopoly on what the sport was created to do — provide a venue to gamble. In fact, modern day gambling opportunities have blown right on by like a dropped down invitational pacer in with nw of \$1000 in the last 5.

Casinos now have found their back door into towns and cities by infesting the racetracks, and eating their young.

Some may say today's surviving racetracks are holding their wagering, but casino wagering at those tracks are blowing the roof off pari-mutuels.

And grandstands are empty compared to racing's heydays.

So what's the fix?

Racing needs to re-invent itself.

Once the leaders do it, the rest will follow.

I repeat, once the leaders do it — WEG and the Meadowlands — the rest will follow.

So what to do?

Start with the product.

1. Get rid of the modern day race bike.

A horse sitting fifth is not five lengths off the lead, but more like 8-9 lengths back, because of the longer shafts, and leaned-back driving style.

Not fair. Not pretty. And certainly not exciting.

Check out North American leading drivers to see how many front-end wins. And who are we kidding with race bikes that allow those heels touching horse hocks.

Not fair. Not exciting and pretty vanilla racing.

2. There needs to be more 'spectacle' albeit 'danger' in a race. Unrealistic, but think along the lines of Roman chariots with razor-edged daggers on the wheel hubs.

Or maybe Calgary Stampede-style chuck-wagon races.

CBS would love the 'Ben Hur' effect.

Current two-turn racing is boring when everyone is on the pylons by the first turn, and maybe a single horse coming first up down the backstretch. Can you imagine a file of thoroughbreds all sitting on the rail?

How about combining two races into one, shorten the charge to the first turn, and race two miles? How about some strategy in a race, with a coach (trainer) mapping out a play to victory?

Say what you will, drivers are not very creative, but then they don't have to be.

Just like today's specimens in hockey, football, and the like, horses need more challenges.

Today's harness horse, with its advanced breeding, is too big and powerful for simple mile events. With 20 horses, the outside 10 hole is back in play, because it is free to ramble, and lock in competitors, using strategy.

As for purses, double them too, with payoffs for the first 10.

And every class gets to play.

More spectacle on the track.

Not enough horses you say?

Eight race cards with horses that go to the post ON TIME!

Now, off the track. This one is simple — more 'creature comforts'. It's all about ME, and what am I going to get?

Casinos learnt this lesson, and master bodies in the seats at the slots. They give away tons. Gifts and meals and bet slips and rooms and tickets.

Long ago, the \$4.99 prime rib dinner at Windsor was so successful, it required two nightly seatings.

Racing today dares you to come through its doors. Maybe a free program, but you print it out. Five programs, and you have to replace that \$20 ink cartridge.

And finally, the television presentations have no entertainment value, or 'sex-appeal.'

Pre-race paddock driver and/or trainer interviews.

Possibly, post-race ticked off interviews make great copy.

In a nutshell, it is as easy as 1-2-3.

- 1. On the track, make racing a 'spectacle' with a danger element, (20 horses over 2 miles)
 - 2. Off the track, creature comforts not just hats.
- 3. Lastly, the big boys start the ball rolling with WEG/Meadowlands and TVC sex-appeal.

You may question the specifics, and have some of your own, but don't dismiss the strategy.

Bali Beach (f Somebeachsomewhere—Hallie Gallie), **Rita Captiva** (f Captaintreacherous—Rita J) and **Lady Midnight** (f
Captaintreacherous—My Lady Love) all looked solid in a mile
around 2:40. They were in a set that had some setbacks due
to illness.

Romona Hill the sensational Breeders Crown winner looked fabulous in her solo mile around 2:20. **Captain Kirk** looked very good in a comparable mile to the filly, also solo.

I am giving some times qualified by "around" because I gifted my mechanical stop watch to Donna Lee and received a digital in return that I was less than proficient in my ability to use it.

Next **Odds On Whitney** (f Somebeachsomewhere—Panera Hanover) the \$400,000 sister to Papi Rob Hanover looked the part finishing on the wire with another nice filly **Odds On Abba** by Always Be Miki out of Classic Star.

On the trotting side, **Simpatico**, the \$9,000 Cantab Hall colt who looked sensational in a heat last week against Maverick the sales topper for 2019, looked wonderful again going a mile in 2:35. He is from the Muscle Yankee mare Miss Otis Regrets. Also with him on the line were **Roberts Hanover**, another colt that looks like a bargain at \$45,000, also by Cantab Hall out of Rule Of Hall and **Cash Hudson**, a homebred son of Chapter Seven—Crazy Grigio.

One that has looked great from day one is **Cervi**, an Always B Miki—Beachesof Cheyene filly she was accompanied by **Angel On Earth** (f Artspeak—Heaven Forbid) and **Notorious Pink** a Captaintreacherous filly from She A Hot Mess going their mile in 2:34.

From Lindy Farms, two colts returning to the wars after suffering minor setbacks were **Okalica** and **KingsCounty** going a nice doubleheader. Both were sound and good gaited.

The homebred filly by Sebastian K out of Product Placement, **Mouse Circus**, went a good solo journey with Frode Fladen, Freddy Grant's assistant at the lines.

Abuckabet Hanover (c Betting Line—All Tucked Up), and **Senor Cool** (c Captaintreacherous—CPA) were at the finish together followed by **Simon Says Hanover** (c Captaintreacherous—Social Scene) and **Pirate Hanover** (c Captaintreacherous—Paris Hanover), all were well in hand. Abuckabet Hanover has been nothing short of sensational since he hit the Florida east coast.

From Team Zeron came a top group of 3-year-olds led by the 1:55 performer **Solsbury Hill**, a colt by Muscle Hill from Emmylou Who with **Illdoitmyself** a Chapter Seven colt from Dornello.

Two 3-year-olds that I really liked last year that ran into minor problems looked great from the Fred Grant barn. They were a filly **Island Lily** by Chapter Seven out of Upfront

Two important questions:



Courant Stable invests a lot in harness racing business and the red and yellow coloured stable has had great success on both sides of the ocean in recent years. Trotters such as Greenshoe, Gimpanzee, Green Manalishi belonged in the top among the 3-year-olds in America last season and even in Europe their horses race with success.

And thankfully for the sport, Courant Stable continues to invest in the game. This week they bought one of the most interesting mares in Europe at the moment.

Undefeated Hillary B.R. (Muscle Hill), who raced for

Gundersen stable in Norway, had to quit her racing career due to a tendon injury last year and the owners Arne Sandbaek Jr. and Erland Åslund have decided to sell Hillary B.R. to Courant Stable.

Sabine Kagebrandt is CEO of Courant Stable.

"We've been looking for a well-bred Muscle Hill mare to use with Greenshoe and Hillary B.R. has everything we're searching for. Unfortunately, she was injured when she was going to begin the fight against older trotters, but instead we now hope that she can produce offspring that are characterized by her. Hillary B.R. is one of the best mares we've seen at the tracks, so we are of course both happy and proud that we can use her for breeding", said Sabine Kagebrandt.

Hillary B.R. did 15 starts in her career which resulted in 15 wins and a lifetime earnings of \$417,500.

Last battle in Paris

The third and last of the big battles in Paris this winter is scheduled today (Sunday, Feb. 23) at Vincennes racetrack and the \$378,500 Prix de Paris is not a race for timid horses. The race is held over 4,150 meters, approximately 2.6 miles, which means two laps on the black track of Paris.

Jean-Michel Bazire tries to catch another big trophy this



winter since he has three horses in the race. This time his choice is Belina Josselyn, who made an early break in Prix de France two weeks ago, while Alexandre Abrivard will steer Prix de France winner Davidson du Pont.

The colt by Propulsion is Wild Honey's first offspring as broodmare.







Anne Schlichtig – trainer

Have you ever wondered what it would be like to train horses for a famous clothes designer? Well, ask Anne Schlichtig.

At one time Schlichtig and her life partner Tom Merriman trained for high-end fashion designer, Roberto Cavalli, in Italy. Two of their Italian stars were Nettare Dei, who won The Premio Renzo Orlandi at Cesena and The Premio Aste at Taranto.

They also had the 2-year-old filly Orata Dei who Anne drove and won her first Italian race.

Later, Merriman drove Orata Dei and was victorious in the prestigious Coppa Dell' Allevamento at Treviso. (see photo below).

The couple privately campaigned for Cavalli, racing at 14 Italian racetracks winning several Gran Premios.

It was at Montecatini that Schlichtig became the first American woman to drive a winner in Italy. Now, that's a hard act to follow.

Born into the business as a second-generation horseman, Schlichtig grew up on a small farm in Huntington, Long

Island.

"My parents had a talented filly named Riverboat who raced at all the New York tracks in the inaugural Sire Stakes program. For three years my mother and I shipped Riverboat to all of her engagements. Luckily, I was never caught by the truant officer for missing school.

"I spent my youth primarily at Roosevelt and Yonkers Raceway where I got my start learning how to care for, shoe and train horses from Dick Baker of the Stanley Dancer Stable. I had the great fortune and privilege of observing, questioning and learning from some of the best trainers and drivers ever; extraordinary horsemen like Joe O'Brien, Howard Beissinger and Jimmy Cruise.

"I wanted to learn as much about the business as possible so I attended The Horse Science School when I was 13-years-old. I went to college at Tulane University majoring in biology and did graduate work in cardiovascular pharmacology. After graduation, I worked as a veterinary assistant to Dr. Raymond Cotter at Roosevelt and Yonkers Raceway.

"When I was 16, I drove my first race in Goshen and when I was 23, I opened my first public stable. In working with and observing many trainers over the years, I learned at an early age to be flexible and attentive to a horse's needs.

"The main difference I see in today's training styles is due to the ease at which young horses train down and the great gaits and attitudes that most possess. I attribute that to our refined breeding programs and expert handling and prepping. A good horseman will moderate the conditioning program with a balance of distance and speed."

Tom Merriman, also a renowned trainer/driver, has driven many great horses. They met in 1977 at Yonkers Raceway where the two raced against each other. Several years later, they teamed up personally and professionally.

They trained for late owner Fred Monteleone, developing and racing the horses Monte Hall and Civil Action. Schlichtig was awarded credit for Civil Action winning the Peter Haughton Memorial in 2001.

Civil Action would go on to win The Townsend Ackerman the following year in a faster time than the Hambletonian on that same day. After earning a million dollars in two seasons of racing, Civil Action was sold to the Italians.

Monte Hall raced the circuit and joined the free-for-all ranks. He retired at the end of his 6-year-old campaign with earnings just shy of \$1 million.

"Later on, I was the sole trainer of the horse Cincinnati Kid, who won The Campbellville at Mohawk in Canada in 2003," Schlichtig said.

"Cincinnati Kid not only won The Campbellville (now known as The William Wellwood) but also set the Ontario stakes record of 1:56.1 — which was the fastest 2-year-old record that year. He shared the time with the great Cantab Hall, whom he would finish second to that year in The Breeders Crown."

Schlichtig has owned and trained hundreds of horses and claims she has had several favorites.

"The one thing they all had in common was a generous heart and gave all they had to offer — regardless of their ability."

Having been in the sport for over 50 years, Schlichtig has seen many changes in the sport.

"Throughout my career, I have raced in New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Kentucky and Ontario. I see the declining interest in our sport and believe it is the victim of a society that demands a faster pace of entertainment and instant gratification. Sadly, I am not sure what one thing would remedy the situation."

Today, Schlichtig helps train for the powerhouse Tony Alagna Stable during the winter at Sunshine Meadows Training Center.

In the summer, Schlichtig and Merriman go to The Meadows Racetrack in Pennsylvania where they are an integral part of The Norm Parker Stable.

I asked Anne if retirement was in the near future, and she laughed.

"No retirement here, folks. This is not a 'job,' but a lifestyle I cherish."

"A stallion owner recruits me. He finds my name posted on one of the six thousand internet job posting sites using an ad."


"And what type of contract terms does a part-time semen salesperson command?"

"Yes. In fact, Trey would work hard, because part of my contract states that 40 per cent of each successful breeding that I am responsible for would be earmarked for me."

"Don't forget that until a live foal is on the ground, the



buyer does not pay. That means that even if you make a sale, you wouldn't see the commission money for more than a year."

"Trey says this is excellent. I will not blow the cash immediately. This pregnant mare would be as close as I ever get to an IRA or hedge fund."

"Okay, let's say you get this bizarre gig. Where would you begin?"

"With data and inventiveness, followed by contacting susceptible relatives and close friends – sort of like selling real estate or life insurance."

"You drain that little pool of prospects quickly, then what?"

"I purchase an unlimited pathway account, round up every scrap of data from every state racing program, data from thoroughbred organizations, from farms that have training centers and breeding farms that do not have racing. I would create more lists than Santa Claus. My lists would be broodmare owners inside the business, plus potential clients outside the business. My first few weeks on this semen gig would be as much data collection as possible. Here's a shortlist."

Jay Bergman, Joe Kyle on ballot for Communicators Hall of Fame

Two veteran harness racing journalists – Jay Bergman, long-time editor / writer / handicapper in the *Sports*

Eye/Daily Racing Form publication family, and Joe Kyle, a noted photographer / writer primarily associated with the Horseman and Fair World magazine, were selected to be ballot candidates for this summer's voting for entrance into Communicators Hall of Fame. Their selection was determined by the result of a vote of the Directors of United States Harness Writers Association (USHWA), the sport's leading media organization, at their annual meeting on Saturday.

Jay Bergman established his excellence in harness racing as the longtime editor and columnist for *SportsEye*, where he highlighted both the equine and human star performers of the sport, featured horses that bettors might keep an eye on for future profit, and also took to task those not adding to the forward movement of harness racing. He served as a freelance correspondent or columnist for many of the sport's major publications, and also did television commentary for a number of harness racing's top tracks and races. A 1984 winner of a John Hervey Award for writing excellence, Bergman is currently a columnist for *DRF Harness*.

Joe Kyle is primarily associated with the Kentucky-based Horseman and Fair World, and was its "go-to" man for both writing and photography when the Grand Circuit made its annual tour of the mile ovals at Indianapolis, Springfield and DuQuoin (IL), and the Red Mile in his publication's base of Lexington KY – a natural association for Joe, who grew up in the Midwest. Kyle saw, wrote about, and captured on film most of the sport's stars in many of the industry's top races, and he won the inaugural George Smallsreed Award for photography in 2001 for a picture of Hambletonian winner Scarlet Knight and trainer/driver Stefan Melander – himself a noted photographer in Europe.

In short, Mr. Finley offers to use his knowledge and skills to guide a group of Floridians to formulate a transferable success model, using PPK as an incubator. All of this while observing, "At one time, cowboy movies had the attention of almost every American "Ironically neither Festus, nor Marshall Dillon or

American." Ironically, neither Festus, nor Marshall Dillon or Ms. Kitty is coming back, and one has to ask whether harness racing ever will. In further irony, PPK may soon go as did

Roosevelt Raceway, Freestate and Sportsman's Park.PPK, like Gulfstream Park, could have been the winter racing capital of the world. Disparate track ownership groups functioning through different corporate boards and values make a unified approach to harness racing near impossible. Any budding owner or bettor would much rather bond with Burke or Tetrick, than we must agree a midlevel trainer or driver. A concept Mr. Finley dismisses. True. Everyone can't be Takter, Gingras and here lately blue collar Surick. But thinking otherwise would be like asking potential investors to buy stock in Charlotte and bypass the Lakers and Heat. (As Mr. Finley surmised, would you rather be in Milwaukee or Miami? The fractional ownership concept has potential, but I don't see transparency in fixed costs and expenses without which most astute investors will never touch it. If Tony ever published an independent audit I would be on board, as I'm sure deep pocketed investors would follow suit, for investment is the key word on top of the fun of it. One writer proposes fixed odds. Certain bettors would have a field day. Go back and research Vegas bookmakers who dropped a dime on certain harness gamblers years ago. Then, the hardworking trainer toiling with overnight stock, troubled by vet bills, rising feed costs, the blacksmith, and owners needing at least a show finish to stay in the business. These folks fight the grind and keep the entry box full. They delegate to others to think and act on their behalf, without benefit of data or concern for it.

So then, how does the industry respond to Mr. Finley's offer of help? I, like he, believe in the power of data gathering and analysis. However, I'm afraid such effort would be useless without power brokers who own, manage and operate tracks at the table. Ultimately, they're the decision makers.
