Dan Patch Awards' Day (Feb. 23) is upon us (stream it live [here](#)). Some of the things we should see include:

1. Chris Ryder getting his long overdue first Horse of the Year (HOY) trophy. He's been a runner-up three times before.
2. A female horse being honored. It was 34 years before any female pacer took home the hardware.
3. We are looking at a deja vu scenario if Twin B Joe Fresh wins and Jiggy Jog S (6-6) is second. In 2001, a female pacer, Bunny Lake, finished first over an undefeated female trotter, Syrinx Hanover (12-12).
4. If females go 1-2 in this year's balloting, think back to 2017 when they held the top four spots! Hannelore Hanover over Ariana G (95-15), with undefeated Manchego third and Youaremycandygirl fourth. All had Yannick Gingras as their regular driver.
5. One last thing, kind of looking ahead to the racing season of Twin B Joe Fresh in 2025. There have been six prior female pacers who've been voted HOY. All came back the following

year – Fan Hanover in 1982, Bunny Lake in 2002, Rainbow Blue in 2005, JK She’salady in 2015, Shartin N in 2020 and Test Of Faith in 2022 – without a single HOY vote among them. Can Twin B Joe Fresh buck the trend?

SPEAKING OF TWIN B JOE FRESH...

Or more specifically “Twin” as in made up of two similar, related, or connected members or parts. When “Twin” B Joe Fresh is nearly unanimously selected Horse of the Year tonight, all of this kicks in;

- Twin meaning nobody in the 21st century has repeated. Never has a female pacer won it twice. All on the table in 2025.
- Twin as in New Zealand again. Brett Pelling was here last year with Confederate and now it’s Chris Ryder for two straight.
- Twin as in HOY and Hall of Fame. Chris Ryder will do both in the same year. Something not done in 54 years, since Joe O’Brien in 1970 with Fresh Yankee.
- Twin meaning a pair of HOY trophies for Dexter Dunn who has the distinction of driving the only unanimous HOY Bulldog Hanover in 2022 with all 136 votes.
- Twin ladies of history. Only two can say they were HOY and had a sub 1:49 mark at 2, 3, and 4, Twin B Joe Fresh and Test Of Faith.

MORE TWIN B JOE FRESH

Since she is the story tonight, here’s a quite unofficial list of the top dozen female pacing efforts.

1. Tarport Hap in 1977, beating the boys in all eight victories.
2. Shartin N posting the 1:46.4 world record in the Lady Liberty that still stands.
3. Shady Daisy just missing a head in 1993 of three straight Breeders Crowns and giving Artsplace all he wanted in the 1992 U.S. Pacing Championship during that one’s undefeated HOY season.
4. Party Girl Hill matching Tall Dark Stranger with 1:47.1 Tattersalls scores in 2020.
5. Silk Stockings’ total domination of her class of 3YOs in the inaugural Monticello OTB Classic of 1975 without an anxious moment as the prohibitive favorite.
6. Eternal Camnation’s three Breeders Crowns and career bankroll of \$3,748,574 that’s not been approached since.

7. See You At Peelers winning her first 22 career starts, most notably the 2011 \$307,735 Art Rooney Memorial against the colts. That pot was the biggest for any female pacer versus the opposite sex this century.
8. Countess Adios winning the 1960 Cane and Messenger. No female has won either in the 64 years since.
9. Belle Acton capturing the inaugural Messenger (1956) and retiring several years later as the sports top money-winner. That race kicked off the Pacing Triple Crown.
10. Test Of Faith’s 2022 1:47 win in the Dorothy Haughton memorial giving Dave Miller his second 1:47 mile with a lady. Previously he’d done so on Oct. 5, 2013 with Shebestingin at The Red Mile at age 3 and that mark still stands.
11. My Little Dragon’s track standard of 1:48 1 at The Meadowlands on July 13, 2007 for Brian Sears and Noel Daley.
12. JEFs Eternity defeating Cam Fella in a 1983 Graduate leg at Freehold on April 9, 1983. She’s the only female to defeat the two-time HOY. She also beat Fan Hanover in 1981 to make her the rare horse to own decisions over consecutive Horses of the Year.

THE DOWN UNDER DIARY

In the Ladbrokes Ultimate Driver Championship Garrard got the trophy but harness racing got the win

“This is the best thing we’ve seen in harness racing Down Under,” said Leviathan owner/syndicator Jamie Durnberger-Smith from Summit Bloodstock on the inaugural Ladbrokes Ultimate Driver Championship after two fun, dramatic and exciting nights of racing at Albion Park.

Global superstars Dexter Dunn, Yannick Gingras and Bjorn Goop added so much to the 20-race series, on and off the track, and all raved about the experience.

It was won by local young gun Angus Garrard, but the real winner was harness racing.

Dunn was the top finisher of the “internationals” in fourth spot with Goop fifth and Gingras tied for sixth.

Angus Garrard won the inaugural Ladbrokes Ultimate Driver Championship at Albion Park with 180 points.



Durnberger-Smith, who had Gingras in his slot, said demand for slots and drivers wanting to be part of the series next year would be “off the charts.”

“You better believe; this has been amazing,” Durnberger-Smith said. “The racing, the way drivers were getting the horses off the gate, all the banter and the build-up, the whole team element. I just loved it; I know our whole crew did. I never wanted it to end.

“Wasn’t it just awesome how much the guys like Yannick, Bjorn and Dexter really got into the spirit of it in the build-up and during it.

“What more can I say... more, more, more. More of things like this is everything we need.”

Gingras, who became a real favorite with Aussie media and fans, said it was beyond his expectations.

“It sounded exciting when I heard about it so I jumped at the chance to be part of it, but I had no idea just how much fun it would be,” he said. “I’ve been in plenty of drivers’ series before, but nothing like this. The slot concept and the draft for drives, they added so much more.

“We also had the best group of drivers, too. Everyone was excited to be part of something new and really made the most of it. “Vicki [Gingras, wife] and I had the best time, on and off the track, and we can’t wait to come back again.”

Dunn, who drove in the Ladbrokes slot, said it was one of the most exciting things he had been part of.

“Wow, that was a hell of an experience,” he said. “It’s the first time I’d driven Down Under since 2018, and what a way to do it. It was amazing how much interest it created. It seemed to really connect everyone – drivers, trainers, slot owners, sponsors and fans.

“They were really smart getting guys like Yannick and Bjorn to come across because they’ll go home raving about their experience and everyone will want to be part of it next year.”

Goop, who said he hadn’t driven a pacer for “about eight years,” won aboard a son of Mach Three (Tracer Bullet) in the eighth race of the series.

It turned around a frustrating start and Goop loved it.

“That’s fantastic,” Goop said. “I’m really happy. Things didn’t go right in the first few races, but to get a win for Scott and his team [slot owner Scott Whitton of Tumby Park] was very good. It’s the first time I’ve driven pacers since the World Driver series in Canada [2017]. It was a long way to come, but I’m so glad I did. It was so different.”

Goop finished with three heat wins, all on pacers.

Garrard, one of two 21-year-olds in the series with New Zealand’s Carter Dalgety, was overwhelmed by the win.

“Just to be part of it, against so many great drivers was a dream come true,” Garrard said. “Winning it is unreal,” he said. “I’m hugely thankful to the SEN team [slot owners] for putting their faith in me and the key runners I got in the draft delivered when I needed them to.

“I’ve been lucky to have a lot of success early in my career, but this is by far the biggest thrill. It’s hard to contain the emotion to be honest.”

Garrard conceded the recognition on an international stage could help later in his career.


“You look at guys like Dexter, Toddy [McCarthy] and Andy [McCarthy] and think about trying your luck at some stage


over here,” he said. “It’s not something I’m rushing to do, but the people I’ve met and the people watching this series will certainly help when the time is right to have a look over there.”

Jessica Otten, the face of Meadowlands media, was part of the Australian trackside coverage of the series.

“So much fun, the trip of a lifetime,” she said. “I’ll go home with lots of ideas for us to explore in the U.S.

“I give all the credit to the people behind the scenes for the initiative to come up with something new for our sport. From

The final word belongs to Racing Queensland’s David Brick, the man behind the innovative series.

TALES FROM THE CURMUDGEON

with MURRAY BROWN

Dr. Paul Nolan on his 50 years of practice

The Dr. John Steele pupil worked with the greats both human and equine.

When Dr. Paul Nolan attended vet school at Cornell, his primary goal was to become a bovine specialist. He had been raised on a dairy farm in upstate New York. His background dealt almost exclusively with cows. His interest and experience with horses had been minimal.

In terms related to getting a more rounded education in veterinary medicine, he was advised to gain some experience working with horses.

Gary Beck, a friend of his in school had worked with Dr. John Steele at nearby Vernon Downs. He provided Nolan with an entree to acquiring work with the then growing Dr. John R. Steele and Associates veterinary group.

Thus began a more than half century of involvement of almost exclusive service to the standardbred and those who care for, train and own them.

In 2018 you retired after 50 years of practice devoted almost entirely to the care of trotters and pacers. Initially you and your wife Ute moved to her native Germany. You have now moved back to the States. Several questions, the first being have you had any regrets about retiring?

“None at all. It was time. This old body had borne its share of wear and tear. I knew I would miss some of the job, most specifically the horses and equally, perhaps even more so, those who worked with them. Through the years I made a large number of friends in the sport. While I was away, I still followed happenings in the game closely. I followed the racing, especially the progress of those I had worked closely with through the years.”

What brought you back to this country?

“Using just two words ‘personal health.’ Our doctors here and the overall health system is probably still the very best in the world. That probably also applies to veterinary medicine.”

Do you now maintain any sort of presence with regard to harness racing?

“Probably only as a fan and as a friend of those involved in the sport. I visit with old friends regularly here at Sunshine Meadows. I watch racing and follow race results. But insofar as actual hands-on participation, none at all.”

You mentioned that when working with Dr. Steele you were somewhat privileged to, in effect, have begun working with the very best in the sport. There were very few of the major Grand Circuit outfits that the Steele group did not do work for.

“It was indeed a privilege. Here I was, a kid just out of school, doing work for such accomplished Hall of Famers as Frank Ervin, Billy Haughton and Stanley Dancer. But not only for them but with several succeeding generations of horsemen. There were very few stables, prominent or otherwise, that we didn’t do work with.”

You were with the Steele group for 25 years. How did that association end?

“Dr. Steele’s association with harness horses was declining. He was becoming more and more involved with show horses. That was an area with which I had very little interest.

“Through the years, I had acquired a good number of clients of my own. I decided that it was time to spread my wings and fly on my own.”

Through your years in the sport, you have been involved with many horses some of them among the very greatest and best known. Are there any that you would care to speak of?

“With each of those horses, there is almost always a story of the human most associated with it.

“One that comes immediately to mind is Vivid Photo and his trainer/driver Roger Hammer. I remember the days leading up to their Hambletonian win vividly – pun intended. Roger told everyone who would listen that he was going to follow Ronnie Pierce wherever he went. If Ronnie took his horse to the grandstand, Roger was going to be right behind him. He did just that and won the race. I doubt that of all the Hambletonians held at The Meadowlands, there has ever been a more popular one.

“Another horse I remember distinctly was Nevele Pride. How could anyone not remember him? He was most deserving of all the negative notoriety he received. Yet his groom, Andy Murphy, knew every hair on his hide and although he never could have been described as a kid’s horse, he was very manageable in Andy’s care.

“Sebastian K for Ake Svanstedt might have been the very last horse that I helped to care for. He was as handsome a specimen as you are likely to find among standardbreds.”

How about the horsemen?

“It began with the greats like Ervin, Haughton and Dancer. It progressed through literally hundreds of others. Some that come to mind are Glen Garnsey, Soren ‘Papa’ Nordin, Fred Grant, Howard Beissinger, the Antonacci team, Dougie Miller, Chuck Sylvester, Gene Riegle, Ron Waples, Doug Ackerman, Jimmy Takter, Ake Svanstedt and maybe a hundred or more others. I know I’ve left many out. For that I apologize.

“I’ve been enormously privileged. I like to think I’ve contributed in a small way to some of the success of the stables with which I’ve worked. With all successful stables, their success is almost always because of a team effort by the component parts of the operation.”

“One [horse I worked with] that comes immediately to mind is Vivid Photo and his trainer/driver Roger Hammer. I remember the days leading up to their Hambletonian win vividly – pun intended. Roger told everyone who would listen that he was going to follow Ronnie Pierce wherever he went. If Ronnie took his horse to the grandstand, Roger was going to be right behind him. Were there any places where you enjoyed working more than any others?

“The two that come to mind were the early days of The Meadowlands and Lexington in the fall.

“Lexington in the fall is magical. If one wants to experience the best that harness racing has to offer, one must be at The Red Mile in late September and early October. The best of our sport, both involving horses and humans are there on full display.”

Ontario-sired horses claimed seven O'Brien Awards, Part 1

This week, a closer look at Monalishi and Stonebridge Wizard.

Ontario-sired horses had their hoofprints all over the 2024 O'Brien Awards, claiming seven of the 13 award categories, including the Somebeachsomewhere Horse of the Year (Chantilly).

Making up the Ontario-sired septet are the aforementioned Chantilly (2-Year-Old Filly Pacer, Somebeachsomewhere Horse of the Year), Monalishi (2-Year-Old Filly Trotter), Stonebridge Wizard (2-Year-Old Colt Pacer), Willys Home Run (3-Year-Old Filly Trotter), Logan Park (Older Horse Trotter), Nijinsky (3-Year-Old Colt Pacer), and Its A Love Thing (3-Year-Old Filly Pacer).

The prominent presence of Ontario-sired winners headlined the 36th edition of the ceremony, held Saturday (Feb. 8) in Mississauga, ON honoring the top performers in Canadian standardbred racing over the previous season.

To ensure that these Ontario-rooted stars and their connections get their proper shine, All Over Ontario is delighted to embark on a three-part series spotlighting the best and brightest to come out of Canada's most populous province in 2024.

Part 1 of our profile – which is devoted to triumphant 2-year-olds, Monalishi and Stonebridge Wizard – leads off with the former.

After finding the winner's circle in six of 10 starts and producing an earnings total north of \$562,000 as a rookie, Monalishi's extraordinary efforts were commemorated with top 2-Year-Old Filly Trotter honors.

It's an accomplishment her conditioner, Blake MacIntosh, said he won't soon forget.

"It's nice to be recognized and that she got recognized," said MacIntosh. "She's a good filly, and she deserved it. We're proud of it, too. We've been nominated a couple of times and never got to win, but we're very happy for the filly. She raced well all season, and she deserved the O'Brien."

Hand-picked at the 2023 Standardbred Horse Sale Company's yearling sale in Harrisburg, PA by MacIntosh, who part owns the daughter of Green Manalishi S—Pretty Phylly G with Tim Klemencic of Trenton, ON, Monalishi affirmed the veteran horseman's inkling that she possessed the power to be great.

“I liked the look of her,” said MacIntosh. “She was really well put together; good size, nice long legs. The breeding wasn’t great. The mare went 0-for-3, but I looked back at my other notes on the family, and knew that the other three all had faults, and she was pretty close to being faultless. So, we took a shot.”

That carefully calculated shot, which at the time cost \$28,000, quickly proved ingenious.

After dropping her maiden voyage, Monalishi caught fire, trotting to victory in five of her next six starts (5-1-0).

The dynamic youngster submitted her finest of several standout showings in a come from behind half-length Peaceful Way score on Aug. 24 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

“We approached it like any other race; nothing different going in the race,” said MacIntosh. “I thought we had a good filly, and we could be right there, and everything worked out. She closed hard and she won the race.”

Monalishi also compiled a near-perfect record across five Ontario Sires Stakes starts, securing four Gold-level dashes with a close second in the Gold Super Final for 2-year-old fillies (neck’s difference).

MacIntosh offered high praise for the “great program” that provides considerable competitive opportunities.

“We go for lots of money, and you hope you have a Gold horse every year,” he said. “We’ve been fortunate to have some. To be able to race every week for between \$80,000 and \$100,000, and \$150,000 is pretty special.

“We strive for that.”

Monalishi is a horse that is better when given space. Getting her into championship form wasn’t always a breeze, but it was certainly worthwhile said her St. George, ON-based trainer.

As the pair gear up for what MacIntosh hopes is another memorable sophomore campaign, he is pleased with the progress his solitary student has made over the winter.

“We sent her down to Anvil and Lace [Farm] in Kentucky, and they did an unreal job getting her fat and back up,” he said. “She grew a lot, lengthened out, and she looks amazing right now.”

The horseman with more than 1,270 training tallies to his name is ready to add to that total with Monalishi in 2025.

“We just want to see her race well, and hopefully she’s on top of her game again and can battle the best all year,” he said.

STONEBRIDGE WIZARD’S O’BRIEN A DREAM COME TRUE FOR BAKO

The 2024 season was also one to remember for Stonebridge Wizard, recipient of the O’Brien Award in the 2-Year-Old Colt Pacer category, and his trainer Jared Bako.

Victorious in five of nine starts across his first professional season (5-1-0; \$284,100), the son of Dancin Lou—Odds On Magic was nothing short of a marvel for Bako, who recorded 112 winners of his own to pass the 100-win marker for the second consecutive season.

The Middleton, NY-based conditioner noted that he had long been eager to work with top-in-class youngsters, and Stonebridge Wizard was happy to oblige.

“This year was my first time having a deep roster of good young horses,” said Bako. “To have that opportunity to train a lot of very nice young horses was incredible, and to top it all off, that colt, in particular, winning the O’Brien is literally a lifelong dream come true.”

Bako and his long-time racing partner David Kryway, the owner of Stonebridge Wizard, had done copious amounts of research on the bay pacer ahead of purchasing him for \$32,000 at the 2023 London Classic Yearling Sale.

While the plan was always to purchase a few yearlings from sire Dancin Lou (also part-owned by Kryway), Bako said Stonebridge Wizard, who checked all the boxes and had the look of an athlete, was the main prize they were after.

At first, however, the rookie racer appeared to be more of a wildcard than Bako and his brother Scott, Jared’s second trainer and Canadian barn manager, had initially anticipated.

“The first day we ever put the harness on him, Scott and I went out to break him – we’ve broken hundreds of horses over the years – and he was the wildest horse we’ve ever broken for a piece,” said Jared adding with a laugh, “There was that split second when we started him up on the racetrack, we weren’t sure we had control anymore.”

That rambunctious, borderline uncontrollable newcomer is now a far cry from the measured, perceptive, and cerebral racehorse that Stonebridge Wizard is today.

“From that moment forward, he got smarter and smarter every day,” said Jared. “Now, he handles everything you throw at him. I’m quite sure I could drive him in a parade, and he would tolerate it just fine and not worry about a thing. It is pretty special to watch a horse transition like that from being so silly about a lot of things.

“Now we look at this horse as a 3-year-old, and I’d send my daughter out to go jog him. My daughter’s not even 2 years old at this point. He’s just that kind of horse now.”

That maturity was on full display throughout the 2024 meet, but it was perhaps best exemplified in a strong-willed Battle of Waterloo triumph on Aug. 5 at Grand River Raceway, where he achieved his lifetime mark of 1:51.2.

While Jared said he and driver Doug McNair knew the \$245,500 contest would be a stiff test, a horse of Stonebridge Wizard’s talents and intellect is by no means a one-trick pony.

“We based a lot of his performance that day on the rigorous training down that we put into our horses to build such a serious foundation into them,” said Jared. “Dougie and I talked about it two days prior, and we didn’t think we’d be able to win out of the 2-hole.

“So, if we made the front, we were going to take our shot... he’s got such an incredible set of manners that you can just wind him up, leave with him, and he’ll sit on the loose line, wait for you to ask him to go again, and he’ll take off again. You call on him again – and he proved it that day – you can keep calling on him, and he’ll keep digging in. He’s a pretty special animal.”

Stonebridge Wizard’s success during the OSS program was also very meaningful for Jared, a native of Aylmer, ON, who hoped to one day emulate the success he watched his father [Laurie Bako] find on the Ontario circuit.

Although he endured a tough go in the Gold Super Final for 2-year-old colts and geldings, Stonebridge Wizard captured two Gold-leg events earlier in the meet to grant Jared’s childhood wish.

“Just before I left, I raced one in the Grassroots Final,” said Jared. “That was my first experience with a stakes horse in Ontario. Then, to be able to send back a horse of that caliber and win at that tier is special to me because that’s where I’m from. That’s home base.”

Over their time together Jared and Stonebridge Wizard have learned plenty from each other. For Jared, his prized protégé’s ascent to stardom serves as a reminder that top racehorses are simply wired differently than the rest.

“Special caliber horses learn to adapt and overcome things so much faster than everybody else, and that’s why they end up being the elite athletes that they are,” he said. “They learn, and they develop, and they react to things so much better than everybody else.”

As far as next steps go, Jared is keen on the prospect of Stonebridge Wizard making another leap in 2025.

“I’d really like to see him make that step to a Grand Circuit colt and prove that he can compete on that level on a consistent basis,” he said.

Achieving that goal will require a team effort from those that are front and center, and others who work tirelessly behind the scenes to make magic on the racetrack.

“I’m very grateful for everyone who has poured their all into getting us into the winner’s circle, including my wife Ashley, who does a tremendous job keeping everything organized and running smoothly day in and day out,” said Jared.

The two top trotting sires battled against each other in Paris several times and with hindsight, it's clear that Maharajah and Ready Cash are two very significant horses key to helping the breed improve.

Ready Cash has played a more significant role as a sire in Europe and among his many offsprings, many are ready to take over the throne as the best stallion in France. Maharajah, on the other hand, will have to rely on just a few sires with his blood in their veins. Still, Maharajah is the leading sire in most of the European countries and his amplitude with big, well-spread crops basically all over Europe, will most certainly put him on top of the sires' list even in the years to come.

When it comes to Ready Cash's sons working as sires, they have together collected many significant races all over the continent and Ready Express, just to mention one of them, already has top trotters like Honey Mearas, Bullet The Bluesky, Calgary Games, Daim Brodda, Stens Rubin and Indy Rock among his best offspring.

A lover and advocate of standardbreds, she soon got a job working for trainer Dan Dailey. Not only was it a privilege to have someone like Dan teach her many things (especially the value of hard work), but she got to spend her winters in sunny Florida instead of the cold winters in New York.

And relocating would bring probably the most exciting thing into her life, for in April 2021 while she raced one of her horses at Monticello Raceway in a \$4,000 claiming race, young Canadian horseman Jared Bako also had one of his horses in the same race. Jared had only been in America for two weeks at that time, but that introduction would change both of the young people's lives. They say, "timing is everything" and "being in the right place at the right time" is so true for that day when these two young people would meet while racing their horses, both of their lives would drastically change for the better! Today, Jared and Ashley are married, and baby daughter Brooklynn makes three.

"Besides Dan, I briefly worked for several other trainers, but what I really wanted to do was become a veterinarian," Ashley said. "I guess God had other plans for me for I found my way back to the horses and I don't regret anything and am so glad to be where I am today.

"Presently, my husband and I run a stable of 52 horses, however the overall number with the broodmares, retirees and babies would be closer to 60."

Jared and Ashley recently purchased a farm in Wallkill, NY, but stable their racehorses at Mark Ford Stables in Middletown, NY.

The Bako's have big hopes for 2025 as they believe they have a pretty strong stable of 20 2-year-olds, both pacers and trotters, which include a blue roan New Jersey trotting colt

that is owned by Houston football star William Jackson III, two Pennsylvania trotting colts and 14 New York hopefuls, a good portion is owned by Blue Chip Farms.

“Since we started training babies, this is the most we have had, and we are loving every minute,” Ashley said. “To work with these young athletes from Day One watching them evolve and make it to the races is so satisfying and makes all our hard work and long hours, worth it.”

The roster includes: (New York) My Philomene, Footsteps Falco, Happy Court, Sipping Firewater, Cocoa Hanover, Colorful Choice, One Fell Swoop, Acoustic Bluechip, Hunt Off The Press, American Cheese and Avalon Bluechip; (New Jersey) Steel Grey, (PA) Major Crimes, Armani Bluechip, (Canada) Aboriginal Bluechip, Byron Hanover and Lou’s Game.

“We also have a very nice group of standout 3-year-olds from Cowgirl Hanover, The Last Martini, Fast Choice, and Stonebridge Wizard who are all champions in their own ways and have proved to be so,” Ashley said. “Wendell Bluechip was a late bloomer, and we are excited about his 3-year-old career, as well as Wisteria Bluechip who only raced twice last year, but was pretty impressive.”

Although Ashley has been in the sport for a short time on her own, her most memorable moment was when her horse Fast Choice won at Vernon Downs in 1:50.3 making it four-in-a-row in the NYSS. She talked about that day with a huge smile on her face.

“There have been many thrilling moments, but Fast Choice was very special to me for the journey that horse went on was incredible,” Ashley said. “Horses like him don’t come around very often. His accomplishments have been nothing short of a miracle and a dream come true since the day I bought him.

“He got injured towards the end of last year, but he is back in training, and we are hoping to have even more success with him this year.

“And of course, Hemsworth N, for he is our fastest horse who took a mark of 1:48.3 on a five-eighths, and consistently competes in the open at Yonkers Raceway and sometimes he competes in major races around North America. I call him my ATM Machine.”

In general, the Bakos race, but also dabble in all aspects of the business. They own a trotting broodmare and Ashley owns a pacing broodmare, both residing at Blue Chip Farms.

Picking her favorite horse was a little tough for Ashley.

“Fast Choice, don’t tell Hemsworth,” she said with a laugh. “Only because I own 75 per cent of him and I picked him out myself in Lexington and my daughter loves him. They are the best of friends, not to mention he has exceeded all expectations thus far.”

The female in the sport that Ashley looks up to the most is her mother, Ann Yurenka.

“She is the hardest working person I know and deserves so much more than what life has given her,” Ashley said. “She works so hard while putting everyone in her life first. While running a business she manages to maintain her very hectic life with her grandchildren and still manages to train and race her horses all over New York, and kills it. In my eyes, no one deserves to be recognized more than her!”

But it’s not just her mother that she gives credit to for her success. There are several people.

“First of all, can I say, ‘my haters?’” she said. “I give credit to a lot of people and no one in particular. Everyone, big and small, who have stood behind us along the way. Jared and I have built everything from the ground up and it wouldn’t be possible without our friends, family, owners and employees. Everyone who stuck with us through the good and bad times and kept us on the right path. One thing about Jared and I, we never settle for ‘as is.’ We strive to be better, especially for our daughter. Our goal is to do the best we can and be better than we did last year. It’s all about growth and success and we are so blessed to have such a wonderful support team behind us.

“And as far as my dream? It is for Fast Choice to win the Little Brown Jug. I realize perhaps it’s a long-shot, but I personally know that dreams do come true.”

The top two over/under trio

Let's drum up some excitement with a revolutionary new wager.

Traditional pari-mutuel wagering feels like an AM radio station that features Polka music. Our attention spans and reading habits have drastically changed in the past few decades. The entertainment value of a trotting horse race is less than breathtaking for most mortals, and future generations will not spend time reading and handicapping a harness race program.

So, let's consider methods of changing the accordion music on our AM station to alt-rock live streaming. Why not change the channel and try to generate direct cash flow to our purses with a revolutionary new wager?

We start the wager by offering a free program that resembles our traditional program with all the data and even more. However, there are two simple adjustments to the program for this wager. The program only has three races of eight horses. Visible on each page of the mini-program is a large box with the number 23. The number 23 is the HOUSE NUMBER for this set. The house number may vary slightly based on algorithms crunching the data for these three races (post positions, field strength, etc.).

Why is the house number posted, and why should anyone care?

As a gambler, your only wager is under or over the house number.

In each of the three races listed in the mini-program, there will be a first-place and a second-place finisher. Let us imagine that in the first race, the top two places at the finish line are the #6 and the #3 horses (the order does not matter; it could be 3 and 6). The important thing for your wager is that when you add the top two numbers together, you have a running total of 9.

The second race goes off, and the top two finishers are the #1 and #7 (or 7 and 1). When you add these numbers together, you will have 8. Now, you add 8 to your running total of 9 from the first race, making your running total 17.

The third race goes off, and the top two finishers are the #2 and #3 (or 3 and 2). When you add these numbers together, your total is 5. Now, you add 5 to your running total 17 from the first two races, making your final running total 22.

This wager uses the total number of the top two finishers in three races to determine the final number. The lowest possible total is 9. The highest possible total is 45. The house number for this set of races is 23.

In the above example, you lose if you wagered OVER (24 and higher). You cannot wager 23 (The House number). If you wagered UNDER (22 or lower), you win and will approximately double the amount you initially wagered. All players will have three engaging races and have a reason to pay attention to all three races.

The HOUSE only gets paid when the house number is correct. For example, in this trio of races, if the finishes total 23, say 6/4 (10), 2/7 (9), and 1/3 (4), the house takes all money wagered into the pool. When the house gets paid, all the money in the wagering pool goes to operating expenses and purses.

A wager such as this would be a hybrid-parimutuel play because a skillful handicapper will undoubtedly use his talents to select an over or under number. On the other hand, this gamble is playable by gamblers who do not know a soccer ball from a salami sandwich.

It's a simple wager.

The wager retains a handicapper advantage and will encourage a transition from just-for-fun players.

The trio of races would last about an hour, retain interest, and build drama.

Late scratches favor UNDER players.

The wager offers a significant amount of interest for the hour invested.

The wager eliminates \$2.20 win tickets.

You bet \$10, watch three races, and have a good chance to double your money.

This wager is an ADD-ON and can co-exist with traditional wagering platforms.

The profit from this wager could be earmarked directly for the racetrack. The house money should be in a separate account or from a separate terminal to help us stand on our own four hooves.

Would you play The Top Two Over/Under Trio?

Shadow Place strikes gold in life after racing

There were many things, a combination of kismet, coincidence, serendipity, and the very definition of a team effort, that brought Shadow Place to his happy place.

“I guess it really was meant to be,” said Tim Dickieson, a long-time standardbred racehorse owner, who along with his wife, Alexandra, reside on a picturesque parcel of land in Holland Centre, ON. “I suppose it is kind of a neat story how this horse ended up at our farm.”

Katie Miller, a longtime horsewoman and owner of Shadow Place, is grateful for the journey that led him there.

“All we can do is put our horses first and I think this is the least I can do for him given all he has done for me,” Miller, a former harness racing driver and trainer, told the [Ontario Standardbred Adoption Society \(OSAS\)](#).

Tim shares the same view.

“We enjoy the horses,” he said. “It can be difficult at times to find places for them. I grew up with horses and lost a few through claiming races. When you get that good bond with them and seeing them move on, it’s like losing anything that is dear to you. My wife and I are just happy to be able to give him a good home and ensure that Katie can come see him whenever she wants.”

The road that Shadow Place, bred by Dan Belliveau, took to his life after the racetrack started just under 14 years ago, on May 22, 2011, to be exact, when the son of Shadow Play—Loving Place was welcomed into the world.

Listed as Hip #1106 at the 2012 Harrisburg Yearling Sale, Shadow Place was sold for \$21,000.

After a pair of qualifiers in June of 2013, one at Mohawk, the other at Rideau Carleton, Shadow Place debuted in the Ontario Sires Stakes ranks, finishing second in a Grassroots Series race at Georgian Downs that July.

One race later, the bay, then under the tutelage of trainer Stephane Larocque, struck OSS Grassroots gold, the milestone score coming at Hanover Raceway.

His biggest triumph and biggest payday came in the 2017 edition of the Gold Cup and Saucer. Considered one of the most celebrated harness racing events in Eastern Canada, the race saw its 65th edition contested last year at Charlottetown Driving Park.

Driven by Gilles Barrieau and trained by Robert Kyle Fellows, who earned his 100th lifetime win with the Gold Cup and Saucer victory, Shadow Place paid \$22 for his signature score.

“Obviously growing up on the east coast, the Gold Cup and Saucer is the holy grail,” Miller shared with OSAS. “So, to take him there, let alone win it, was beyond anything I can ever

describe. I actually thought I was going to pass out walking back to the winner’s circle that night. He stood there for 20 minutes, like an angel, while people took very muddy photos with him.”

The gelding, who posted purse earnings of \$136,000 in 2017, also enjoyed other OSS successes and winner’s circle trips throughout Ontario, as well at a few U.S. racetracks, during his racing life.

Shadow Place’s curtain-closing race failed to produce a Hollywood-type finish. But the sixth-place finish on Dec. 17, 2021 – he finished less than three lengths back of the winner – did nothing to sully a fruitful career. His speed badge, 1:49.1, was collected at Woodbine Mohawk Park in his 5-year-old campaign. His final winner’s circle trip came six weeks prior to his final start, a gate-to-wire score in 1:55.

Miller, at Shadow Place’s side for much of his career in various capacities, was his trainer for the final nine starts of his career.

His stat sheet shows 142 starts, 27 wins, 13 seconds, 19 thirds, and \$360,539 in purse earnings.

“When I retired him four years ago, he had a tendon injury and he stayed with me until the opportunity came through OSAS to give him an amazing forever home with Alexandra and Tim, who are lovely,” said Miller, who is a detective with Regional Police in Waterloo, ON. “I personally can’t provide such a picturesque property for him to live out his days and may never be able to.”

Shadow Place is now part of a horse family, living a good life along with the saddle horses and standardbreds who also reside on the farm.

“He’s so well-mannered and is so good with kids and other horses,” said Tim, who owns a handful of standardbreds. “He fit in right away. He settled in nicely. We turn him out with the other horses, and they get along so well. We take them in at night and give them a nice supper, a couple of apples, and tell them we’ll see them in the morning.

“He’s easy to get along with. Our youngest son, who will turn 18 soon, wasn’t around horses much growing up, and he’s taken right to him. He told us, ‘He’s the easiest one to get along with out of all of them.’”

Longtime supporters of OSAS, Tim and Alexandra are well-versed in what the organization does for retired racehorses and their connections.

In late 2024, Tim reached out to Joanne Coville, who has served as events coordinator with OSAS for several years, in addition to several other horse racing roles, including outrider duties at the Woodbine Entertainment racetracks.

It would be a game-changing conversation for many, including Shadow Place.

“I knew Joanne from the racetrack, and we had donated to the OSAS golf tournament – it’s such a great cause,” said Tim. “I

touched base with Joanne after my wife and I had talked about looking into adding a few more horses to our farm. I told Joanne that if we could help in any way, we'd be happy to do so.

"When we spoke, Joanne said, 'Tim, it's funny you should mention that. We have a horse who won the Gold Cup and Saucer in 2017. She knew I had one [Likemebettor] in that race last summer, plus my family roots are from there, so there were some interesting coincidences there. That's how it all started."

The beginning of a story that would produce a fairytale ending.

"It is exactly that," said Tim. "It's a good experience to look after a retired horse – the transition of watching them race to then enjoying their life after that. A vast majority of the people involved with racehorses have the same mindset – they love animals and want to do what is best for them, not only on the racetrack but also when their careers are done."

The door is open for Miller to visit the farm any time.

"It's obvious how much Katie cares and loves this horse, so we are just happy to provide him with a home and have her pop up any time she wants to visit him," said Tim. "I know how they have a strong connection, and we want it to continue."

After 142 race miles, highlighted by a golden moment on Canada's horse racing-rich East Coast, Shadow Place is feeling right at home in his surroundings.

Tim can see that with his own eyes.

"We have six here right now," he said. "We wake up, go out and have breakfast on the patio, and it overlooks the horses in the field – you never grow tired of those moments. Shadow Place – we're just fortunate to have him with us."
