Teenager Carey Le Cain not only helped Ahi recover from the First Line Training Center barn fire and return to the races, she did so as the pacer's new owner.

The teenager with the big heart and the pacer who defied the odds were undoubtedly meant for one another.

just over three years ago.

“After the fire, I met him and there was something about him that me realize he was special,” said Le Cain. “I loved him right away and I wanted to do whatever I could to help him.”

And so she did.

Le Cain doted on the bay son of Sportswriter and helped him through his rehabilitation process from the injuries he had incurred from the fire.

Along with her brother, Brodie, Le Cain, who worked in the stable of Mark and Shawn Steacy through a co-op program at her school, played an instrumental role in Ahi's return to the races.

She was there when the pacer, bred by Hudson Standardbred Stb Inc., had his picture taken in the winner's circle at Flamboro Downs on Jan. 4, 2020, his first racing mile since he was sidelined by the aftermath of the fire.

It was also Ahi's first win since Aug. 14, 2018.

"That was amazing," said Le Cain of the three-quarter length score with Shawn Steacy in the race bike. "That just showed what he was like. He never gives up, he always tries and he shows the

big heart that he has every day. It was pretty exciting. It was that 'little horse that could' moment. To see him out there, trying so hard and winning... it was really special. He had been through so much and overcome so much, and to see him standing in the winner's circle was something I will always remember."

When she found out that Ahi's connections were thinking of selling the horse, she had only one thought in mind.

"I went home and told my dad [horseman, Scott Le Cain] that I wanted to buy him and that I'd do whatever it would take to make that happen."

Le Cain, then 17, went to work, literally, in her quest to purchase Ahi. She worked five days a week for the Steacys, worked for horse owner Mary Christopher on the weekends, and did stall gigs on Sundays.

All of it – long days, early mornings, and late nights – would finally pay off.

On Oct. 5, 2020, Le Cain took ownership of Ahi. Shawn Steacy continued to hold the reins as the conditioner.

Eight months later, at Hanover Raceway, the pacer and his proud owner celebrated a first together.

"I didn't think he had won," said Le Cain, of the head score. "My friend told me that he had won and I had never run across the track at Hanover as fast as I did. It was close, but when I looked at the replay, he stuck his head out and you could see he got it."

The narrow margin of victory made the moment that much sweeter.

"You always want to win those close ones and he found a way to do it. He was just himself, giving everything he had to get the win."

When the starter began rolling on the night of Jan. 6, it provided yet another first for Le Cain.

The owner added a new role to her racing repertoire, that of trainer.

"It's stressful at times because I'm off on my own now. Going from a groom to now, it's been a lot of learning and finding out things on my own. My dad, he's always there if I need him, which is a good thing to know. It was tough at the beginning when I started owning and training because I was so used to asking people questions every day. And when you own him and train him, you realize, 'This is my horse.' That was something I had to get used to."

One thing she didn't have to familiarize herself with was knowing every inch of the horse.

Whether it was the mornings, the minutes leading up to a race, or preparing for his next start, Le Cain and Ahi are undeniably in sync with each stride he takes.

"On the track, he always tries. When you're jogging him, he's quiet as a mouse. Most of the time, I jog him, but sometimes, my dad helps me out. It's nice when Ahi and I are just out there by ourselves, just sharing that time together. It's always something I enjoy."

Le Cain, who has worked for veteran horseman Jack Moiseyev since last November, helping him with the training of his standardbred band on his farm, is embracing her busy life.

As for her future plans, the 19-year-old, based out of First Line Training Center, is still mulling over her options.

“I’m not really sure what my big goal is yet. I own half of a McWicked filly with Mary Christopher, so that would bring me up two horses. I guess having about five or so horses would be ideal for me. Right now, I’m going with the flow.”

That means staying grounded throughout the ups and downs of owning and training a horse.

“In this sport, there are always challenges in whatever job you do and I think I’ve learned along the line that patience is something you have to have. At times, things can get frustrating, but you always find something that keeps you going.”

In this instance, it’s Ahi, the little pacer that could.

“There aren’t many horses like him. It’s very hard to describe. Everyone says they have the best horse, but for me, whenever I look at him, I see something special, something that you really can’t find the words for. All I know is that he is one of a kind. It’s very peaceful working with him. You think of all that he went through and how far he has come. That is something that will always be very inspiring for me.”

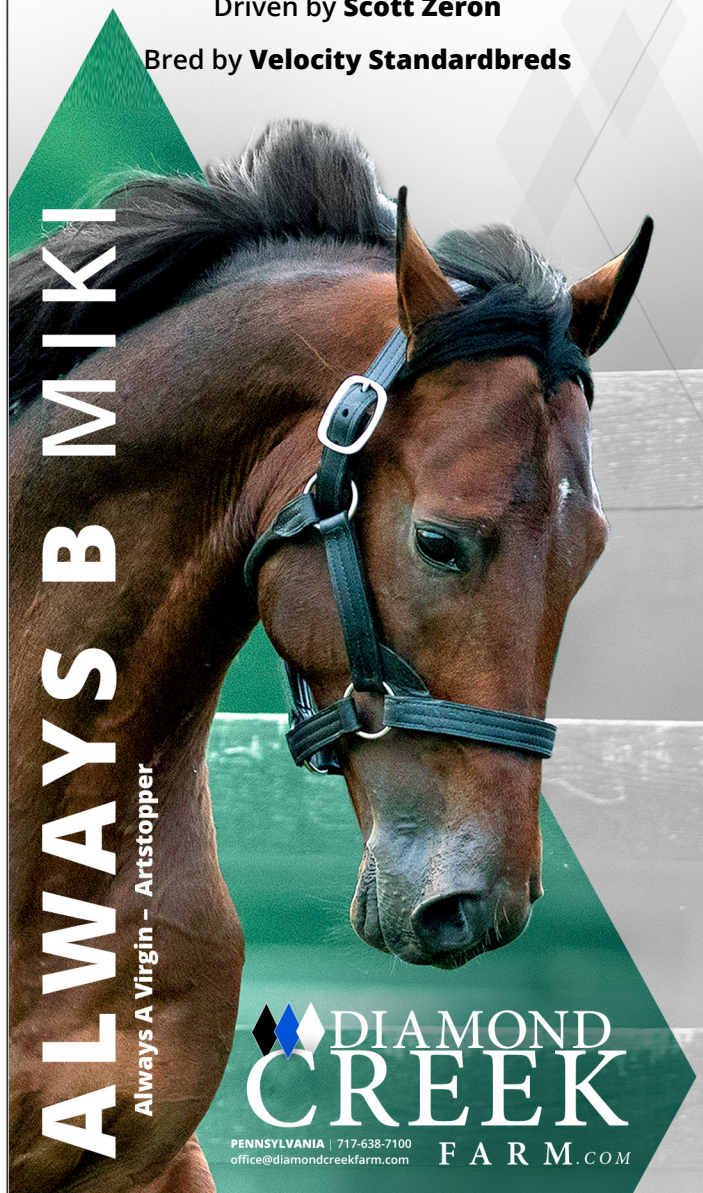

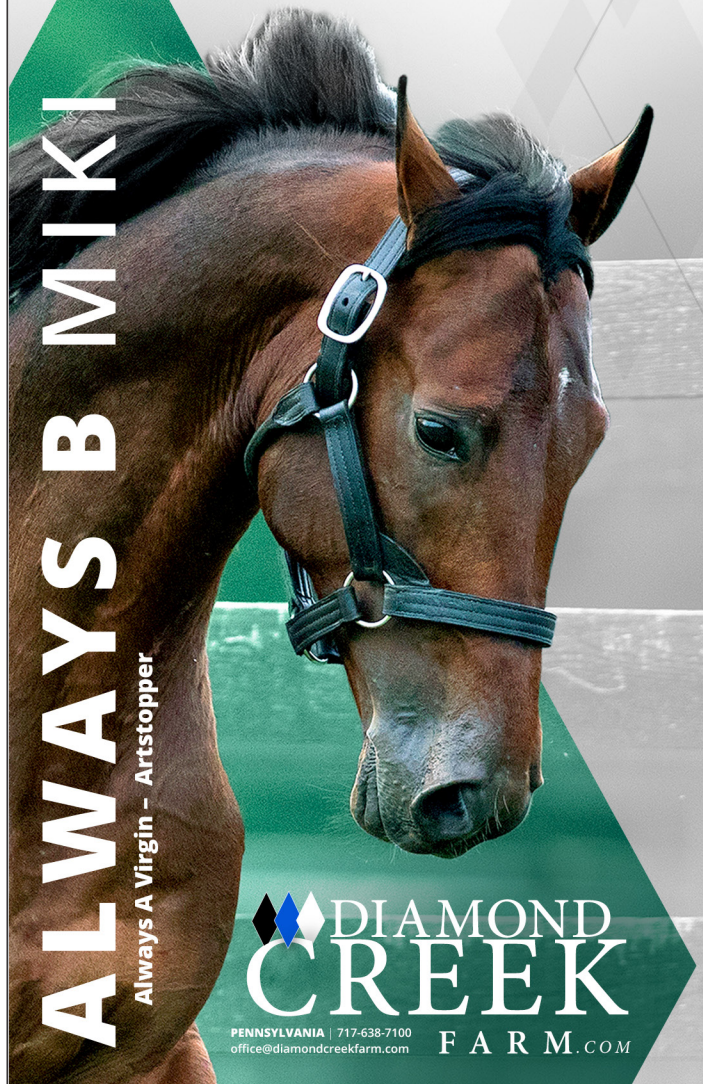

"I was getting home from the gym. It was late and [Mark] called me and I sat in my car for almost two hours parked outside my place talking to him about what we can do," said Demsky.

MacDonald wanted to do something to make horses more exciting. He had many ideas, including trying to mic up the drivers the way they do in NASCAR.

"I said, Well, there's a race call, and NASCAR has a production staff of probably 40 people monitoring everybody's audio, so, no, we can't do that," said Demsky. "And he doesn't like to hear the word no. So, I said, let's get a mic on you and another driver and see what that is. So, we did that and I said why don't we do this every week?"

Demsky had been working on a similar mic'ing idea and already built graphics that became the opening animation for Mark On Mic.

MacDonald likes it when players in other sports, such as football, are mic'd on the sidelines and thought something like that would be good for harness racing.

He had also been asked to wear a mic in a race in Canada over the summer and even though the mic went dead halfway around the last turn, he had fun doing it.

"Around the same time down here we were talking about needing transparency," said MacDonald. "To me it was like if you want transparency, there's your transparency."

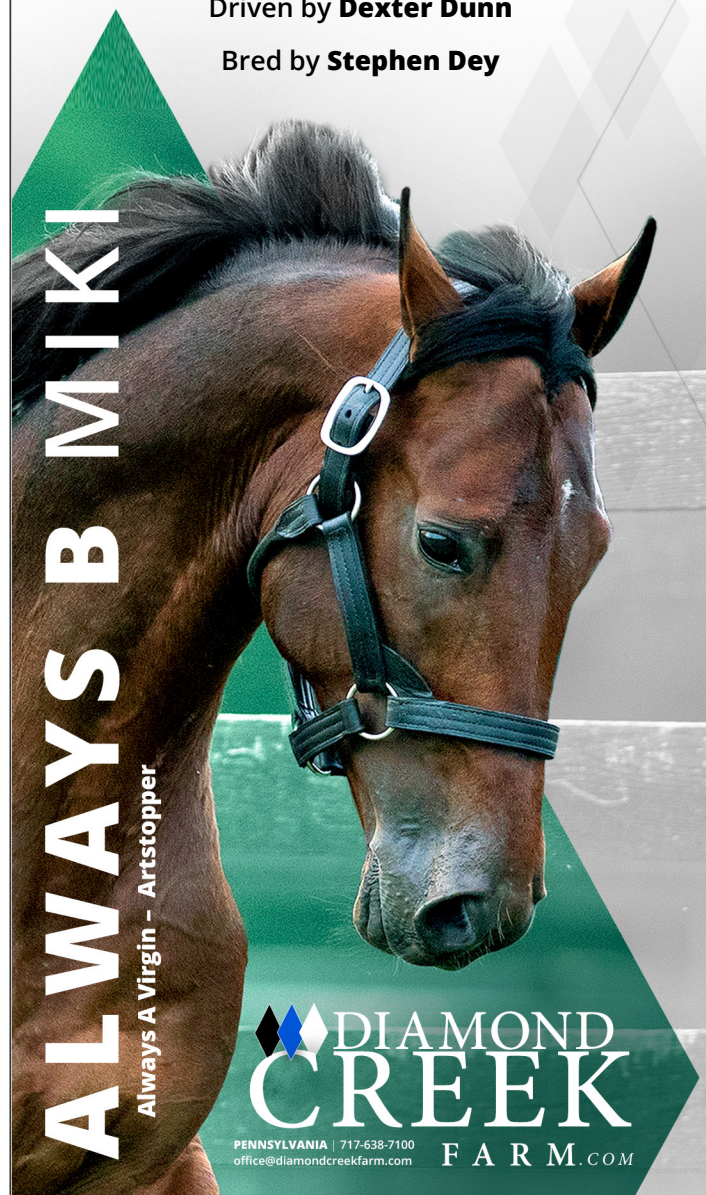

MacDonald and a guest driver talk about their horses, the competition and race strategy.

For Demsky, the approximately five-minute feature can take as much as eight hours to put together before they drop on social media every Wednesday at noon.

"Shades has done a great job," said MacDonald. "Fifteen minutes of audio, piecing it together with video and putting in the live race on top of it. I think he does a great job editing. I've seen my brother Curtis do it and I know it's not an easy job."

MacDonald's brother, Curtis, is the owner/operator of CUJO Entertainment and specializes in productions like this.

"I remember Curtis doing the editing and he'd be over there for hours and he'd show me what he did and it would be like a two-minute clip and I'd be like are you kidding me?" said MacDonald.

For Demsky, it's important for the clips to have a storyline and one of them is MacDonald consistently poking fun at driver Todd McCarthy.

"Me and Toddy are good friends and he can take a good ribbing," said MacDonald. "He just kind of rolls with it. I make fun of him and he makes fun of me right back, but I've got the camera, so the joke's on him."

McCarthy was only a guest on the series once and it looked like he was going to win but his horse broke at the top of the stretch.

"It is a great thing I think, it's just been really unlucky the way it's turned out like that for Mark," said McCarthy. "But I think it certainly is great for the industry. And Mark's great at it. He could talk underwater. So, if you need a guy to be on in a race, he's the perfect man for that job, I think."

In the first two episodes, the guest drivers – Dexter Dunn and Andy McCarthy, respectively – won as the favorite. Unfortunately, that trend didn't continue.

In the 11 episodes to date, MacDonald has never won and the guests have won a total of three times.

One driver was overheard in the paddock saying that the best way to get a 2-5 shot beat was to put a mic on him.

MacDonald takes it all in stride and remembers the sage words given to him from legendary PEI horseman Mike MacDonald.

"[Mike said] 'My definition of luck is when preparation meets opportunity,'" said MacDonald. "If there's a camera on your bike or there is not a camera on your bike it doesn't make one little bit of difference. I've got 10 or 11 wins at The Meadowlands this year and it's a hard place to win."

What people probably don't know is since Demsky has other responsibilities at The Big M, his opportunities to mic up MacDonald are in many cases limited to a Friday night rather than a Saturday when MacDonald would have a much better chance to win.

The series will continue through the end of March when Demsky has to go back to work at Tioga Downs.

The hope is for MacDonald to get a win before then, but either way he's good with what they've accomplished.

"It's kind of a running joke, but just the fact that we're having this conversation about it, I've already won," said MacDonald. "If it's gonna make people talk, hey, I wonder if this one's mic'd up, if they're paying attention, that's good for us. That's good for our game."

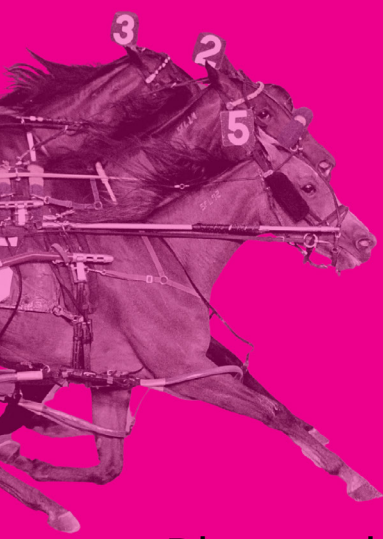

Ageless wonder Southwind Amazon is set for return

Southwind Amazon (Camluck—Artoonist) will make a highly anticipated seasonal debut on Sunday (Feb. 27) at Northfield Park in the \$19,500 open handicap. The 12-year-old gelding, who has become known in recent years for his guts and grit, will be racing for the first time in nearly four months.

Owned since early 2016 by Michigan-based Ameer Najor and

trained by Paul Holzman, Southwind Amazon was last seen in a race on Oct. 31. On that frightful Halloween night at Northfield, he broke while on the lead approaching the half-mile and was eventually pulled up. Preliminary reports that night were that a rock had gotten wedged under the horse's shoe, and that he had no swelling nor was showing any favoritism when walking. Following a battery of tests to determine what happened, Holzman no longer believes those initial indications.

"We were never fully able to identify the exact problem," said Holzman. "We went through him with a fine-toothed comb, we x-rayed him with attention to his left front, but those x-rays didn't really show a hill of beans. We x-rayed him at three different intervals, three weeks apart, to make sure there wasn't a hairline fracture coming through that we didn't see yet. The only thing that the x-rays showed – and keep in mind he's 12-years-old – was a little activity with his left front sesamoid. But there was no fracture, no lines, nothing that meets the eye and like I said, he's a 12-year-old and that's activity you could see on any racehorse that's been around that long."

Because Holzman and team was never able to put an exact finger on the injury, Holzman treated the horse as if he had a hidden hairline fracture that couldn't be seen.

"I stall rested him six weeks like he had a fracture and through that six weeks he was absolutely raring because he doesn't like to be cooped up. So, we treated him to speed up heal with the bone structure and one thing that did come to sight from that race, he had a little swelling in his high tendon on the left front, so I cryo'd that and shocked it a couple of times and he's made a whole recovery."

Though definitely pinpointing the cause of the incident remains nagging, the best Holzman can do is surmise.

"I still believe, in my head, what happened was he stepped in a hole. I scoured the replay about 100 times, and I did see some minor foots and steps into that first turn, which is out of character because he's typically flawless. The track was kind of bad that night and I think that whatever he did, it got to him the next turn because of the left front pressure on the banked turn. I can't prove it, I don't know for sure, but it made sense to me after seeing the aftermath the next morning when he was completely sound and never really showed distinct lameness after that night."

Having been managed carefully since that time, Southwind Amazon returned to the Northfield Park on Feb. 16, winning a qualifier in easy wire-to-wire fashion in 1:54 with a last quarter of :27.4.

"It was just what I wanted," said Holzman. "Ronnie (Wrenn Jr.) of course came in to qualify him and he hadn't been driving

him too recently, but he's won probably 80 or 90 per cent of the horse's races and he knows him very well. Ronnie was very happy with him, and said he was raring to go and had plenty of pace. This was his first actual downtime from an injury and he seems to be handling it, he qualified as good as I could expect."

To date, Southwind Amazon has amassed 114 career wins from 289 starts. He's taken sub-1:50 marks each of the past six years, including four of which have been taken on Northfield Park's half-mile track, most recently a 1:49.3 mark from Northfield as an 11-year-old. I'm certain that no other horse in harness racing history has established four separate 1:49-and-change seasonal marks on a half-mile track. For that matter, it's probably not even happened three times, let alone four. And with as fast as he's paced for as long as he's raced, Southwind Amazon ranks seventh all-time in career wins. But despite being a single win away from sixth and within shouting distance to Rambling Willie in second, Holzman is going to let Southwind Amazon dictate his own course.

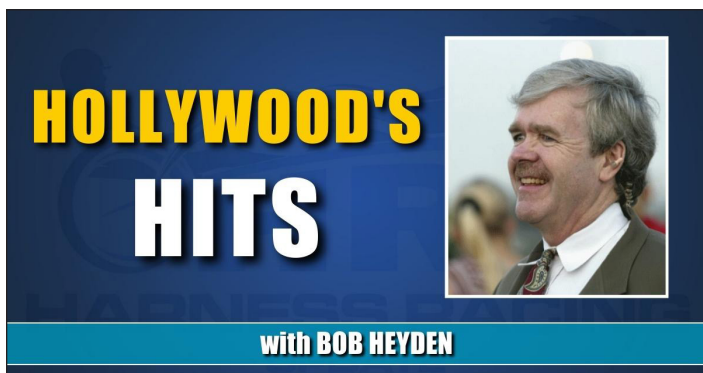
"Since (the injury) happened, we take every day he races as a bonus," said Holzman. "If anything ever has to be where I have to retire him, obviously he owes us nothing and that's always something in the back of our minds. With the miles he's gone these years, with bad posts and outside draws, 45 starts a year with a lot of brutal trips in the middle and all that he's done against top level competition in Ohio and elsewhere – we're just taking this time as a bonus."

One of those brutal trips was last year's Battle of Lake Erie at Northfield when Southwind Amazon was terrorized from post 8 in a race won in 1:47.3 by This Is The Plan. But no matter, three weeks later Southwind Amazon was at it with another record.

"He came right back from it," said Holzman, referencing the Battle of Lake Erie race. "I took him to my hometown track in Northville, they had a late closing series for Michigan-owned or bred horses. And he set the all-time track record of 1:52, which is unheard of there. He was pressured through fractions of :26 and :53 which is all unheard of, and it was special to me because I grew up at that track, and he'll live with that record there forever. No horse is ever going to pace 1:52 there, unless he goes back and does it again."

"What he has done and managed to do, he's a freak of nature. He's built like an athlete and up until this injury he's taken care of himself and kept himself sound, which has been part of his success. He is a different species; he breathes different air than most horses and he's an absolute pleasure. He almost has a personality of his own and we read each other's minds; I'll tell you that."

Bella Bellini is trained by Nifty Norman and also driven by Dunn.

As for the Aussies, Andy McCarthy drove Ramona Hill (2020) and Jujubee back to back and Todd McCarthy had Anoka Hanover and Allywag Hanover consecutively. This makes them the first brothers to win Dan Patch Awards as drivers in back-to-back years.

Just 71.1 per cent of the year-end ballots sent out were returned. Were these the same people who-a half century ago said no to Sandy Koufax, when he received just 86.9 per cent of the 1972 Hall of Fame votes?

Feel good moments of the night

It was a tie.

Greg Wright, Jr. winning the Trotter of the Year award for Jujubee and bringing his father's name back into the harness racing conversation. Greg, Sr. was the leading trainer at the Meadowlands each of its first four seasons.

Mike Tabasco, caretaker of Jujubee, a harness racing lifer who has endured, persevered and triumphed having the time of his life with this fantastic trotter.

No senior tour necessary

David Miller drove three of the four 2021 millionaire horses in the industry at age 57:

Perfect Sting \$1,273,847.

Test Of Faith \$1,069,739.

Venerable \$1,039,966.

Dexter Dunn drove the other, Bella Bellini (\$1.1 million).

Kentuckiana's fun night

Big representation from the ownership of HOY Test Of Faith, -among them the forces behind Kentuckiana Farms. Remember they bred the 1993 HOY Staying Together, who is still the last horse to lower the all-time race record a full second – 1:48.2 in 1993 down from Artsplace's 1:49.2 in June of 1992.

Pacing fillies-1-2

For the first time ever, pacing fillies were 1-2 – Test Of Faith and Niki Hill. Sophomore fillies went 1-2 in 2001, but it was pacer Bunny Lake and trotter Syrinx Hanover.

Deja Vu? Let's hope not

Brett Pelling last won the HOY title in 2005 with Rocknroll Hanover, then left for a decade going back home.

Youngest guy, fastest horse

Todd McCarthy, at age 27, had the fastest mile of 2021 when Allywag Hanover won in 1:46.4 at the Red Mile.

Dexter power

Dexter Dunn has been voted Driver of the Year in his first three full years in North America. No other driver in the 21st century has matched it. For three straight years he's had the HOY runner-up: 2019 Bettors Wish, 2020 Party Girl Hill and now 2021-Niki Hill. And he's not 33 until Sept. 1.

Happy 65th birthday Tommy Haughton

The youngest ever to win either a Hambletonian heat (23 with Final Score in 1980) or a final (25 in 1982 with Speed Bowl), Tommy Haughton hits 65 on Sunday (Feb. 27). Look at the following list he now belongs on:

Seven drivers since 1950 have won their first Hambletonian and lived at least 40 more years:

1. Harry Harvey won in 1953 with Helicopter at age 29 and lived a record 63 more years.

2. John Simpson, Jr. is at 52 years and counting since his 1970 score with Timothy T at age 27.
3. James Arthur won the 1961 Hambletonian with Harlan Dean and is the only other driver to surpass a half-century making it 51 more years.
4. Howard Beissinger took his first Hambletonian at age 46 and lived another 49 years.
5. Delvin Miller won it in 1950 with Lusty Song and the sport lost the Miller 46 years later.
6. Ray Remmen was 34 when Shiaway St Pat got it done in New Jersey in 1981. The Chief is still here 41 years later.
7. Tommy Haughton at 65 is #7. His father, Billy Haughton, didn't win the Hambletonian until he was 50, then won an amazing five in a nine-year span.

He took on the huge undertaking of the Meadowlands, The Giants, The Nets and Continental Arena – quite a task. Rarely does an employee get to know and fully appreciate his boss of bosses. But that was the case for me. In 1997-1998, Mulcahy was vying for the athletic director's job at Rutgers University – my alma mater. I wrote a letter to them that they published in their quarterly magazine, emphasizing that it is rare to go to a State University and then work for that same state in continuity – and that Bob Mulcahy was a difference maker who got things done. He made all of us better. Then, he got the job and came to the Meadowlands on a special trip to thank me. Of course, I didn't think my letter was a big factor, but it probably didn't hurt. He made it his business, like always, to reward the people – nobody too big or too small – who teamed up to make the product the best they could. He did this in a most dignified way, without ever calling attention to himself. Not once.

Remembering a great man, Robert Mulcahy

The CEO of the New Jersey Sports and Exhibition Authority's Sports Complex from 1979-1997. He was 85. He was a quiet, mild-mannered man, with a towering presence.

Joe McGorisk dead at 86

Long-time Detroit/Windsor racetrack man and world-class human Joe McGorisk died Feb. 19 at the age of 86.

McGorisk started his career in the harness racing industry at the Michigan tracks Hazel Park, Wolverine, DRC, Northville and Jackson. He made the move to Windsor Raceway in 1965. He was a marketing genius, operational director, admissions director and ended his career as senior vice-president at Windsor Raceway. Many looked to him as a mentor as his guidance was a springboard to their successful career paths.

McGorisk was a get-it-done, behind-the-scenes guy with an irrepressible sense of humour and gift for Irish bull. Few people, if any, were more likeable.

McGorisk had a rare gift. He was liked and respected by virtually everyone – from management to the dishwashers; from millionaire owners to the first-time groom.

There's countless stories of McGorisk quietly helping someone down on their luck or going to bat for someone looking for a second chance.

His official title for many years was the director of operations for Windsor Raceway. Basically, he was the man that kept the place running. He just did his job to the best of his ability 12 hours a day, seven days a week for over 50 years.

McGorisk began working at racetracks in 1953 when he was a high schooler in Detroit.

After high school, McGorisk took a day job on the road selling footwear for B.F. Goodrich – better known today for its tires – and kept his night job at tracks in the area such as Hazel Park.

In 1956, McGorisk moved up his draft day and did a stint in the Army. When he returned to civilian life, he completed a degree in management at the University of Detroit while also working at Hazel Park at night. He tried teaching for a short time, but it wasn't for him.

When Windsor Raceway opened in the fall of 1965, it was something of a pioneer of winter racing. As the Detroit tracks were mostly seasonal, Hazel Park general manager Sid Anton was brought over to run Windsor. Anton brought McGorisk with him.

As a further indication of McGorisk's workaholic nature, he

continued working at all the Detroit-area tracks – usually one during the day and another at night – until 1989 when Tom Joy bought Windsor Raceway and soon hired McGorisk on full time.

It was one of the best decisions Joy ever made.

McGorisk saw and focused on the good in all people. Always ready with a sincere, genuine, heartfelt compliment. He built people up. He was a role model, intelligent, charismatic, a bunch of fun, lover of life and laughter, story teller, wordsmith, stand on a chair to make an announcement or toast, kind of guy.

He was an editor and proof reader of important papers and applications. He was a poet and writer, a joker and an entertainer. He embodied some sort of bottomless well of joy that he selflessly shared with others. And that sharing was like a dance that he did with you, in fact, with everyone he encountered. It was like a little jig, and when he really got going, which he always inevitably did, it looked like he was really dancing.

He had a very strong faith, and the deepest love for his wife, Susie, and all of his family. They had a beautiful relationship that has been exemplary.

He was a devoted husband, dad, step-dad, friend, brother, son, best papa and a complete gentleman. He was a hard worker, always dressed to impress, freshly shaven and smelling of nice cologne. He was a shopper too, buying Susie lovely and practical gifts on a regular basis. They were an incredible team together, that did countless jobs and events to raise money for different groups and foundations.

His cherished memories will remain with his wife, soulmate and best friend Susie (nee Wright); children, Patricia (Sam) Phillips, Lisa (Scott Lites) Jackman, and Keith, and their mother, Jeanie (Stroker); grandchildren, Lucas, Logan and Declan; step-children, Jodi (Bil) Nolin and Jeff (Amy Smith) Kessel; and step-grandchildren, Tate, Ben, Reed, Pebble, Sylvester, Essie and Solomon. He was the loving son of the late Beatrice and Cornelius, dearest brother to Neil (late Terry), late Charlie and sister-in-law Sheila,

and late twin brother Gene (Christine), and dearest brother-in-law to Wayne (Carol) Wright and Greg Wright. He will be missed by many nieces, nephews, Superior Street Gang, Windsor Raceway crew and dear friends in Canada and the United States.

USHWA conducts annual two-day meetings during Dan Patch USHWA weekend

In conjunction with the annual Dan Patch Awards Banquet for the best and brightest in North American harness racing 2021, including Horse of the Year Test Of Faith, the banquet's host, the United States Harness Writers Association (USHWA), also held its two days of annual meetings at the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort in this central Florida city, with the Directors gathering on Saturday afternoon and the general membership on Sunday morning.

The directors were responsible for taking the five finalists from the chapters' nominations for the Communicators Hall of Fame and bringing the number to two for inclusion on this summer's Hall of Fame balloting. The directors selected Bob Roberts and Ken Warkentin.

Roberts, now retired, is the Ohioan who has covered both standardbred and thoroughbred racing with passion and insight for several decades, while Warkentin came stateside from Canada and soon wound up at The Meadowlands, where he has been calling the races, including the prestigious Hambletonian, for three decades.

The directors also considered several changes to the operating practices of USHWA. Two notable decisions were allowing the consideration of a veteran nomination for the Hall of Fame every year instead of its former three years, and the reinstatement of the second vice-president's position, so that eventual presidential candidates will bring a wider wealth of experience

to efforts in tackling that difficult job.

During the Sunday meeting for the general membership, the budget committee noted that the success of the 2022 dinner would allow USHWA's cash standing to come back to its 2020 level – the highest in the organization's history – after COVID felled the 2021 banquet, by far the greatest source of revenue for the organization. Sales of sponsorships for the 2022 reached an all-time high and led the areas that sparked the comeback.

The assembled membership heard reports from other committees, and from the organization's officers. Both of these groups thanked the many people with whom they worked to help allow USHWA to make its maximum contribution to the sport of harness racing. One surprising note was that the membership of USHWA, despite the setbacks and stop-start racing schedule which have been trademarks during the virus pandemic, had actually grown in the last year, with USHWA now numbering over 200 national members.

Finally, the officers for the 2022-2023 operating year were elected. Barry Lefkowitz, a board member as both vice-president and treasurer within the last few years, was elected without opposition as president; Michael Carter, who has been on the USHWA board of directors for several years, was similarly unopposed in becoming first vice-president. Kim Rinker, completing a two-year term as president, became the USHWA chairman of the board per the provisions of USHWA bylaws. Returning to their USHWA roles unopposed were Bill MacDonald as treasurer and Jerry Connors as secretary.

He was supplemented to the \$179,200 Matron at Dover Downs where the gamble paid off in a decisive 4-1 victory in 1:55. The payday punched his ticket for the Valley Victory where he overcame a rough start to finish a solid fourth. Campaigned in Canada by Jason McGinnis and in the U.S. by Jim King Jr., he was piloted exclusively by Canada's Driver Of The Year, James MacDonald.

Buoyed by a Pick 5 carryover of \$12,840.97 that drew in \$94,000 and change worth of new money, Yonkers Raceway hit the seven-figure mark in wagering handle on Tuesday night's (Feb. 22) 11-race card, with the final number totaling \$1,030,607.92.

The Pick 5 returned \$3,733.25 to those sharp enough to go five-for-five, and driver Austin Siegelman was the star of the sequence, winning with 19-1 shot Bet On Blake in race five, 3-1 offering Roll With Jr in the eighth, and 2-1 High St Corridor in the ninth. Both Roll With Jr and High St Corridor are trained by Nick Devita, while Dennis Laterza trains Bet On Blake.

In addition to the action in the Pick 5, the Pick 6, which started with a carryover of \$3,618.73, brought in \$9,272.60 from bettors, and one winning ticket collected \$9,182.

Batavia Downs GM Haight to retire in March

Todd Haight, the long-time general manager and director of live racing at Batavia Downs, has announced that he will retire from that position at Western Regional Off-Track Betting Corporation effective March 15.

"I would like to thank WROTB chairman of the board Richard Bianchi and all the directors for their support over last 20 years. I would also like to thank my dedicated co-workers who proved to be a great support system for the live racing department, and the members of the Western New York Harness Horseman's

Association that I've worked in conjunction with for many years," said Haight.

Haight started at WROTB in 1998 as an independent contractor and later became an employee when the historic racetrack re-opened in 2002.

He first co-hosted a nightly live broadcast of races on cable TV with track announcer John Bothe. Then in 2005 he joined the corporation's marketing department and that allowed him to reinstate all the great promotions that occurred at Batavia before WROTB purchased the Downs.

"I was able to bring back the popular driver's bike race on Labor Day and the old fashioned hot dog days and our fans responded in big numbers once we did. Another popular promotion we started and grew was the wiener dog races and it's nice to see so many other race tracks are doing them now," said Haight.

"I was also able to hit the streets to sell advertising and more importantly, develop great relationships throughout the community. We used those relationships to bring businesses – many of them for the first time – to the Downs for a night at the races. Working with group sales manager Mary Bucceri, we routinely sold out the clubhouse. Those groups affected the corporation's bottom line with sales surpassing one million dollars."

Haight explained his most valuable experience during his tenure was to work side-by-side with then WROTB vice-president and general manager of live racing, Mike Kane. He said that although he already knew the racing side of the business, Kane's mentoring on the management aspect made all the difference and was a roadmap to success for him.

In 2011 when the WROTB board of directors promoted Kane to president, Haight was promoted to general manager and he remained in that position through his retirement.

The racing product grew under Haight's watch and in 2013 betting rose 24 per cent. Incremental year over year increases continued until 2019 when the track hosted the prestigious New York Sire Stakes Night of Champions and saw new records set for both total betting handle and nightly betting handle.

"I was very happy with the way the Night of Champions turned out. It was the biggest card of racing here since the 1988 Breeders Crown and it was simply a great night, from the crowd to the racing to the event itself. The entire staff here stepped up and did an incredible job," said Haight.

"We got through the pandemic relatively unscathed in 2020 and despite not having spectators, nightly betting doubled the levels of 2011 and crushed the records set in 2019. Last year we tried some new things and you could look at the tote-board and clearly see our pools were bigger. We ended the year up about \$3,000 per race, which was another record since WROTB took over the Downs."

Haight is currently a USTA director and the chairman of District 8 and will remain in both of those positions. And regardless of which job he was doing, his hard work promoting the sport of harness racing has not gone unnoticed by his peers.

"It was my pleasure to work with Todd for the past 10 years. As general manager of racing at Batavia Downs, Todd had an amazing mastery of the many responsibilities his job entailed. I will miss working with him as he was a true professional. I wish him all the best in the years to come," said Bruce Tubin, president of the Western New York Harness Horsemen's Association.

"Todd has been a pleasure to work with and he will leave big shoes to fill. His kind are a dying breed in that he cared for racing so much. I wish him the best of luck in retirement," said Kim Crawford, director of USTA District 8.

"I have worked with Todd at Batavia Downs since 2014 and can tell you there is no one in this industry who worked harder to promote harness racing than him. Appeasing an established customer base while trying to draw the next generation to the sport is not easy, but he maintained that delicate balance which in turn drove increased handle and attendance to the track year over year. He will certainly be missed," said Tim Bojarski, racing publicist and president of the Upstate New York Chapter of the United States Harness Writers Association.

As far as retirement, Haight isn't sure about his future and has indicated that he has several options.

"If it's playing a lot of golf I'm okay with it. And if it's remaining in the horse racing industry in some capacity, I'm okay with that too. In any event the last 20-plus years have been good to me and for that I'm extremely grateful."

All 2022 Ohio foals will be nominated to Grand Circuit races at Delaware County Fairgrounds

The Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association and the Little Brown Jug Society have announced that all Ohio Sired foals registered by Dec. 31, 2022, will have their yearling nomination to the Grand Circuit races at the Delaware County Fairgrounds paid.

The Grand Circuit races include the Little Brown Jug, the Jugette, the Old Oaken Bucket and the Buckette.

The goal is to make more Ohio-sired horses eligible for the races and to raise purses with the goal of a \$1 million purse for the Little Brown Jug.

"This announcement is a great opportunity for the Delaware County Fair and the horsemen and horsewomen of the state of Ohio. We are excited to see these Ohio foals compete and win on a national level," said Tom Wright, president of the Little Brown Jug Society. "A big thank you goes to the OHHA for their tireless promotion of our industry."

"Over the years there have been Ohio-sired horses not eligible for these prestigious races in their home state simply because they missed the yearling nomination payment," said OHHA executive director Renee Mancino. "We are happy to finally bring horseman James Mulinix's suggestion forward and provide a safety net for Ohio Sired horse owners and breeders on the yearling payment. We also anticipate a boost on the overall purse money offered in these races moving forward."

The initial nomination payment for yearlings will be calculated as part of the support the OHHA provides to the Society for the races.

2022 Empire Breeders Classic information

Tioga and Vernon Downs will again play host to the \$1 million Empire Breeders Classic (EBC) for New York-sired 3-year-old pacers and trotters this summer. Sustaining payments for the 2022 races, nomination payments for foals of 2020 to race in 2023 and the stallion eligibility payment on foals of 2021 to race in 2024 are all due (postmarked by) March 15.

The EBC was conceived in 2007 by Jeff Gural to provide New York-bred sophomores an opportunity to race in a high dollar,

state restricted stake. Over the subsequent 16 seasons, more than \$14 million in purses have been distributed to those NY breders that have competed in the stake.

The purse is funded by an annual grant from the Agriculture & New York State Horse Breeding Development Fund, Tioga and Vernon Downs stakes purse accounts and NY Stallion owners along with the payments made by the connections of competing horses.

The 2022 EBC will be raced as it has been for the past two years, a single event with no eliminations scheduled and the race will be divided with the purse and entry fee split equally by the number of divisions. Over those past two seasons, three of the eight events have drawn enough entries to be split into two divisions while the other five have gone as a single race for the entire purse.

This year, the EBC trotting stakes will be raced at Vernon Downs on Friday, June 17 while the pacers are scheduled for Sunday, Aug. 28 at Tioga.

Tioga Downs will also play host to the \$1.6 million New York Sires Stakes (NYSS) finals this season on Saturday, Sept. 10.

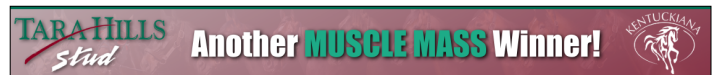
