MOHAWK MILLION gaining momentum

The 2023 edition will go ahead. All nine slots have been sold for the fourth edition.

On Monday (Feb. 27), Woodbine Mohawk Park revealed the names of the seven slot buyers for the 2023 Mohawk Million. The \$1 million (all money in CDN \$) Grand Circuit event for 2-year-old trotters features a unique format where owners, trainers, and breeders can purchase \$100,000 slots for unspecified horses by a Feb. 15 deadline. The slots can later be transferred or sold. Particular trotters being entered only need to be named the week before the draw. This year's race is scheduled for the star-studded stakes card on Saturday, Sept. 23 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Bill McLinchey, director of standardbred racing for Woodbine Entertainment, said he was appreciative of the continued support from major players in the industry.

"It was great that it filled," McLinchey said. "It came right down to Feb. 15 again, like the first three editions."

Two owners – Gino Toscani of Mount Hope, ON, and Determination (Serge Godin) of Montreal, QC – each bought two 2023 slots.

"It shows a huge commitment on their part," McLinchey said.

Individual slots were purchased by another five participants. The winner of the William Wellwood Memorial final at Woodbine Mohawk Park automatically earns a reserved slot.

Greg Luther (formerly Black Magic Racing LLC) of Blacklick, OH, is back. He entered standout Indiana stakes filly Yo Beth D

(2, 1:54.3s; \$299,650) last year after negotiating for the Mohawk Million slot originally purchased by Doug Overhiser of New Smyrna Beach, FL.

Anthony Lombardi of Morris, IL, was part of the 2022 purchase with Overhiser, which was subsequently sold. This time, it's Lombardi's name on a 2023 slot.

"We're not part of those transactions," McLinchey said. "Some know they don't have [a competitive 2-year-old trotter] and they're shopping around that slot early. Most are doing

it the weekend before the entries are due. There’s a lot of communication and wheeling and dealing. The slot owners make the transactions and notify us.”

Ecurie CSL (Sylvain Deschenaux) of Sorel-Tracy, QC, bought a 2023 slot. Last year, Deschenaux and co-owner Sophie Bourgeois’ 9174 7998 Quebec Inc. were represented in the Million by Ontario Sires Stakes Gold winner Dws Point Man (2, 1:55.1s; \$185,398).

“He purchased Crawford Farms’ slot last year, at the time of the draw,” McLinchey said. “He enjoyed being a part of it. It was really encouraging to see him come back.”

Courant Inc. (Anders Ström), Delray Beach, FL, invested in a slot for the inaugural Mohawk Million in 2020, entering the now-exported Iznogoud AM S (3, Q1:54.1; \$37,300 prior to export). After a two-year hiatus, Courant has returned for the latest edition.

“I’m assuming that ties in with the Greenshoe [3, 1:49.4m; \$1,353,772] babies,” McLinchey said, referencing the hotly-anticipated first crop of the 2019 Dan Patch Trotter of the Year, who was campaigned by Courant.

Hunterton Farms and Partners have continued to support the Mohawk Million, which has proven to be a mutually-rewarding combination. Last year’s Mohawk Million champion Oh Well (2, 1:53.1m; \$740,380) is owned by S R F Stable of Lighthouse Point, FL, and competed in the slot secured by the Paris, KY, farm.

"Hunterton Farms back in as a breeder is great to see," McLinchey said. "It must have reflected positively on the yearling sales for them."

The first two winners of the race were bred by Steve and Cindy Stewart's establishment: Dan Patch 2020 Trotting Colt of the Year Venerate (4, 1:51.1m; \$936,735), and 2021 Dan Patch and O'Brien 2-Year-Old Trotting Filly of the Year Venerable (2, 1:52.0m; \$1,187,798).

McLinchey said he was pleased that the *Toronto Star* published a *Canadian Press* article about the Mohawk Million slots this week.

"We're really going to work towards ideas so that it stays fresh and continues to fill," McLinchey said. "The Pegasus [thoroughbred slots race at Gulfstream Park] format has continued to change over the years. We're planning and always looking for ways to make our owners feel appreciated; that it's not a regular night."

Trainer Luc Blais agreed that the Mohawk Million is no ordinary race.

"We love that race," Blais said. "I think that it's exciting. I know that for [Determination owner Serge Godin], it's very exciting. It's a million-dollar race at Mohawk, our home track. We have a farm here, close to the track. So that's why."

Determination has also had success in past editions.

"We've been lucky in that race," Blais said. "We were second two times [with fillies Donna Soprano (2020) and Silly Me Hanover (2022)] and third [with 2020 William Wellwood winner On A Streak] in that race. We participate every year and the goal is to win the race. I think that it's like the Breeders Crown, the same level and prestige... It's very good for the game to have a new event like that."

Blais is currently training 10 2-year-old trotters for Determination and acknowledged it's much too soon to know which ones will be ready for the Mohawk Million.

"If you talk right now, I have a good feeling, but you know, when you're closer to qualification, you know more," Blais said. "I like what I've got right now."

Fillies have had a strong showing in the richest race for 2-year-olds, allowing for more choices when it comes to deciding which horses take the slots.

"Sometimes the filly is more mature than the colts," Blais said. "When they're good, they're good."

While the big event itself is months away from the first baby races of 2023, the Campbellville, ON, trainer said he is looking forward to it. Even the release of the slot owners' names generates anticipation each year.

"The people advertising that race do a very good job," Blais said. "Every year when we get close to that day, it's exciting. It's always a last-minute call. It's interesting."

International Women's Day will be celebrated at The Meadowlands on March 4.

In honor of International Women's Day, The Meadowlands will host an event sponsored by Clinton Tractor that will have Jessica Otten, 26, and Ashley Mailloux, 29, co-host both the pregame and live broadcasts tomorrow night (March 4), starting at 5:45 p.m.

Otten, marketing coordinator and TV host for The Meadowlands and Fox Sports, is excited for the opportunity to work with Mailloux again and, for the first time, on the set.

"After not doing so much last year, I figured we should step it up this year," Otten said. "I reached out to Ashley and I'm happy she was available."

Mailloux, a freelance analyst for various entities both standardbred and thoroughbred, is excited to work with The Big M team again after a two-year hiatus.

"It's been a while since I've been there," Mailloux said. "I'm excited that I have the opportunity to go back. Jess and I have worked together but we've never been able to co-host a show and I think that's huge for International Women's Day."

"I think when you look at the sport as a whole, there are a lot of women involved and not necessarily always in the spotlight. So, I think The Meadowlands having an International Women's Day is a huge accomplishment and it kind of highlights that. So, I know Jess and I are both looking forward to kind of shining a light on all the women in racing."

Otten pulled out all the stops for this event, which will include an "In the Sully" with driver Lauren Tritton, taped interviews as well as live ones from the paddock and two races featuring female drivers.

When Otten first thought of holding a women's race she was worried that she might have trouble getting participants, which was clearly not the case.

"I didn't realize [on Feb. 1] when I posted for any female driver to contact Scott Warren that it would get so much hype so quickly," Otten said. "Which was great."

2023 Breeders Crown Foreign Stallion Nomination Form



Up to 15 North American Foals of 2024 by Foreign Stallions may be made eligible to the Breeders Crown with a payment by **March 15, 2023** of a Foreign Stallion Nomination Fee equal to the amount of the North American advertised service fee for a 2023 breeding. (\$500 U.S. funds minimum)



Additionally, any foals that are **foaled & registered in North America which are produced from mares bred outside of North America** may also be made eligible by a payment of the advertised stud fee in the country where the stallion stands. This payment provides Breeders Crown eligibility for a North American crop of up to 15 foals.



If the Foreign Stallion's **North American Crop is 15 foals or less**, that payment is the total amount due for these North American foals to be eligible to make the 2025 Yearling payment and maintain eligibility by the future payments to the Breeders Crown. Any additional amount ("surcharge") or refund of this nomination fee will be determined by the number of 2024 foals ("North American Crop") by these stallions standing outside North America ("Foreign Stallions") and foaled and registered in North America (either with the U.S. Trotting Assoc. or Standardbred Canada) as of August 15, 2024. All foals which are nominated as yearlings must be registered in North America at the time of nomination.

Meadowlands’ racing secretary Warren thought the response was “far more and quicker” than for similar events that he’s worked on in the past, pointing out that he received emails as soon as the post went up and even had to turn some people down.

“You’ve got to at least hold a “P” license [to compete in these races],” Warren said. “I actually had a couple of inquiries from people that had a “Q/F” license.”

The event will appropriately represent International Women’s Day, since one quarter of the participants are from outside of the U.S., with three from Canada and two from Denmark.

“It’s not every day, obviously, that you see a female driver,” Mailloux said. “I was excited to see how successful it would be and how many women would want to participate in this event and to hear that there’s going to be two full fields I think is huge and really exciting. It’s going to be awesome to witness live and we’ll see what happens.”

Some of the U.S. drivers — representing Maine, New Jersey, New York, Ohio and Virginia — have experience racing at The Big M, while others will be making their debut at the mecca of harness racing.

Owner/trainer/driver Mariah Wright, 30, will be making her first appearance at The Meadowlands both on and off the track

despite the fact that Otten’s been trying to get her to The Big M for five years.

“My best friend has lived there for five years and I’ve yet to make it out to see her,” Wright said with a laugh. “We grew up together. Our parents knew each other before we were born. I guess I can say I’ve known Jess her whole life and she’s a couple of years younger than me. We grew up together around the Michigan fairs and we have pictures of us as early as 3 or 5 years old at the fairs together.”

Wright is an only child so Otten is the closest thing she has to a sister.

“I’m really proud of her,” Wright said. “Where she is in life and just everything. She’s done more than I could ever imagine for her.

“I’m excited for her, because this is kind of her thing that she’s put together and I’m excited to be a part of it. She called me and told me about it and I said, ‘Oh, that’s so cool’ and she said, ‘And you’re coming? And I’m not taking no for an answer.’”

There will be special "Women's Day" coolers – provided by Corporate Images, Inc., a women-owned business – for the winner of both races that will be presented by Meadowlands' assistant general manager, Marianne Rotella, and director of marketing and event operations, Rachel Ryan as well as Otten and Mailloux.

It's also in the works to have a mic on a couple of the drivers and Shades Demsky has offered to edit the footage which should drop on Wednesday, March 8, which is officially International Women's Day.

Provided the forecast of a winter storm tonight (March 3) doesn't rain on their parade and prevent competitors from arriving, everything is set for a big night.

"Women can basically do anything," Mailloux said. "We're powerful. We can do anything that we want if we work towards it. I think it's more of a day to celebrate how far women have come, all of our accomplishments, but also that there's still change needed and we're heading in the right direction.

"To see women shining in all areas of the sport, that's certainly something that women should be proud of."

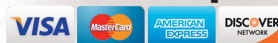

Europe's new queen Ampia Mede SM scored in the Prix de Paris

The Fabrice Souloy-trained **Ampia Mede SM** (Ganymede) continued her strong meeting in Paris by winning the \$420,000 Prix de Paris over 4,150 meters, establishing her position as the best mare in Europe at this moment.

Ampia Mede SM's runner up finish behind Hooker Berry in the Prix d'Amérique was in some way proof of what would come in the two remaining Grand Prix-races at Vincennes during this winter meeting.

In the Prix de France, Ampia Mede SM bested her opponents via an outside leader trip and when the Prix de Paris was on Vincennes' Sunday (Feb. 26) race card, driver Franck Nivard just had to trust his horse as he found a spot fourth over.

Her attack with cover, three wide, was made on the backstretch and Ampia Mede SM came in contact with leader Harlem du Bucy as the home stretch began.

Harlem du Bucy was the race's least merited trotter but he held his pace strongly in front and really challenged the top horses that gathered at Vincennes that day. Ampia Mede SM proved to be best once again as she disarmed the leader with 100 meters to go and her meeting in Paris 2022-23 has been successful, to say the least. She's the new queen of trotters in Europe, without a doubt.

The mile rate for Ampia Mede SM over 4,150 meters was moderate; 2:02.3. Harlem du Bucy was second and Prix d'Amérique winner Hooker Berry was third.

4-, 5- and 6-year-old trotters closes the gates of Vincennes for the season.

Saturday's edition of the Prix de Selection is a heavy one with many powerful horses starting over the distance of 2,175 meters where the 5- and 6-year-old trotters have a 25-meter disadvantage.

Eric Raffin, who was injured in a race some weeks ago, will be back in the bike behind his Prix d'Amérique weapon Horsy Dream.

Inspirational words keep third generation horseman Zackary Gray committed to the business

"Keep on truckin,'" is the only way Zackary Gray knows.

There have been times, both personally and professionally, when the young horseman from Malta, NY, has felt at his lowest point, unable to see much, if any, reason for optimism.

But when he is faced with such moments, the 22-year-old recalls the advice he received from his late father, words that have been echoed by another respected figure in his life.

They never fail to inspire.

"My dad, Bobby, it was about two years before he passed away, he told me, 'Just keep truckin,'" Gray said. "He said whatever I faced, that I should never give up. And that stuck with me, and I've stuck by that. I've had a few down times in my life, but I always keep going."

Gray's association with standardbreds can be traced back to the days before he could walk and talk.

In fact, his first trip to the racetrack came not long after he was welcomed into the world.

"I'm a third-generation horseman," Gray said. "I think I went straight to the barn as soon as I was born. When I was about 5, I started working with the horses and I jogged my first one when I was 8. It was one of [trainer] Jimmy Nickerson's horses. I remember the moment. It was pretty cool, just that feeling of

being behind that strength and athleticism. I was hooked from that moment."

Seven years ago, when he was 15, Gray and his family moved to Saratoga when his father took a job in the stables of Heidi Rohr and Nickerson.

Wherever the horses raced, Gray was happy to be along for the ride, eager to lend a helping hand to his father in whatever way he could.

It was in New York when Gray started to sit in the sulky, but he was more enamored with the training side of the sport.

When his dad died in 2018, Gray continued his education in the industry and at the same time, intensified his pursuit of a harness racing career.

His rookie season, in 2022, was an undeniable success.

On April 15, he sent out his first winner, Star Of Terror, a bay son of Western Terror, at Cumberland Raceway in Maine.

Gray, who had moved to Maine from New York to kick-start his career, didn't have to worry about a photo finish in his milestone victory, an emotional triumph that prompted thoughts of how his father would be proud of him.

"One of my best friends, Wil Dubois, he sent me the horse," Gray said. "He won by 8 ½ lengths that race. I was really excited. At the three-quarter pole, he let him out and he was just flying. At the top of the stretch, I knew he was home free. It was pretty exciting. It was awesome."

So too was the purchase of Cool Jack.

He recorded over \$200,000 in career earnings and had nearly a dozen different owners, including Gray’s mom, Sheryl, over his racing years.

“[Trainer] Joe Facin told my dad, just before he passed away, ‘I’ll get your kid a horse,’” Gray said. “We bought the horse and two weeks later, my dad died. So, this horse is very special to me. This summer, he was racing at Plainridge and he snapped a pastern. We had to put him down, which was tough. I know I’ll never forget that horse. He was a cool horse. You could do whatever you wanted with him. You could ride him and he would just follow you around. You didn’t even need a lead shank on him. He was the best horse over. When you were feeling down and out, he always came through. He always found a way to battle back.”

Just like Gray always has.

His passion for horses and the sport he loves keeps him moving forward.

Control Tower, an 11-year-old son of Panpacificflight, also owned by his mom, is another favorite horse of his.

“I’ve always wanted to race at The Meadowlands and we had the chance to do that with him,” Gray said. “He finished third [this Jan. 22] in a race there and missed winning by just over a length. We came back to Saratoga in mid-February, and he won at 60-1. He’s such a nice horse. We’ve had him since December when we claimed him. He’s won almost \$500,000 in his career and he has over 40 wins. He’s one of those ones that always tries hard, even when the odds seem to be against him.”

Currently, Gray runs a stable of a handful of horses, an ideal number for the time being.

While he might look to expand his operation, it certainly won’t be by much more than what he already has.

Goal-wise, the big picture for Gray comes in the form of a short-term viewpoint.

“I really like to take things day-to-day, maybe get a few owners and a couple more horses,” Gray said. “We would all like to win the Little Brown Jug, so that would be the ultimate dream. But I think five or six horses would be ideal. My mom is my biggest owner now and she is also my biggest supporter. She has always stuck by my side. She’s the best. I’m just happy to be where I’m at now.”

At a point where he didn’t always think he would be.

It’s why every morning he steps into the barn is a scene he never takes for granted.

“When they pop their head out and they are happy to see you, it always makes you smile,” Gray said. “The horses, all they have is you. It’s awesome to see them.”

After a rookie season that produced 23 wins and \$103,339 in purse earnings, Gray will work to an even stronger sophomore campaign.

And he’ll do it, as always, through the lens of one day at a time.

“I look back to my first week of training and every horse I had finished last,” Gray said. “It wasn’t very good. I was ready to give up and my mom told me that I need to keep going. I worked for [trainer] Jaymes McAssey at Saratoga for three years and I called him up and said, ‘I’m ready to give this up.’”

And then Gray heard those inspirational three words his father had shared with him.

“Jaymes told me, ‘Keep on truckin,’” Gray said. “He told me to work hard and things will eventually pay off. The next week, I won three races. I heard those words from my dad and then Jaymes said it too. And that’s what we did.”

Driver Ridge Warren aims to continue going forward

After setting marks for wins and purses in 2022, he's looking for more.

Last year was the most active of Ridge Warren's driving career and it resulted in several highlights, including new marks for wins and purses, his 1,000th lifetime victory and the 1,000th triumph for a family member that perhaps was the best moment of all.

Now he is looking forward to seeing what 2023 brings.

The 34-year-old Warren has been driving since 2007 but averaged fewer than 500 starts per season prior to relocating from Illinois to western Pennsylvania in 2020 and making Hollywood Casino at The Meadows his home track. Since then, Warren has averaged nearly 1,500 starts per season, and in 2022 he set career highs for starts (1,856), wins (200) and purses (\$2.29 million).

He ranked sixth in victories at The Meadows last year with 155. He also began driving at Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania, where he just missed a Top-10 finish.

"I really put in the time last year," Warren said. "I did seven days a week last summer for maybe four or five months straight. I was going full tilt, just spreading my wings a little bit more and giving myself an opportunity to grow.

"It was pretty awesome; I was really fortunate. The 1,000th win was a nice milestone and then to see my numbers continue to increase, it really makes you feel nice about putting in the work. So, I'm excited to see what this summer has to offer."

Warren is the son of driver-trainer Todd Warren, who has more than 5,200 wins in the sulky and 1,010 as a conditioner. Todd got his 1,000th training triumph last June when Ridge drove Eye Of A Tiger AS to victory at Oak Grove. It was one of only two training wins last year in which Todd didn’t sit in the bike.

“My dad was one away and had a trotter he thought could win,” Warren said. “He drives fulltime himself, but he asked if I wanted to drive, so I flew down to Oak Grove and got the win. That was the highlight of last year, and probably my career, to be honest, just to be a part of that with him. It was pretty cool.”

The win came less than a month after Ridge got his 1,000th driving triumph at The Meadows.

“Winning is the joy,” Warren said about what he most enjoys about racing. “And I really enjoy getting the opportunity to sit behind nice horses. I’ve gotten more opportunities now to sit behind real nice horses, well-bred horses. It makes it that much more fun.”

Warren, a Michigan native, got the driving bug as a teenager and started in the sport by helping with his father’s stable. He got his first driving win with Prairie Zeke, trained by his dad, at Maywood Park in December 2007, just four days before his 19th birthday.

He enjoyed success on the Chicago circuit, but as opportunities decreased in Illinois, he began to explore other career options. Soon, he was racing on a part-time basis at Hawthorne while running several small fitness centers.

“I learned a lot about small business and I learned a lot about working in a normal job, going in and running meetings and stuff,” Warren said. “It was different. But I’ve always loved being around the horses, and I’ve always loved driving. I realized I really wanted to be in the bike more and wanted to give my shot at fulltime and put my effort into it.”

In 2020, the time was right. Warren was ready to get out of the fitness center business following the coronavirus pandemic and had a friend who frequently suggested Warren try racing at The Meadows when Hawthorne was on hiatus. In addition, Warren’s girlfriend, Erin, had just gotten a job in Pittsburgh.

“The stars kind of aligned there,” Warren said. “The gyms offered me an opportunity to get out and go our separate ways. I thought this is the best time for me to try this. So, that’s what I did.”

So far this season, Warren is sixth at The Meadows with 25 wins. He plans to keep a schedule similar to last year, racing at The Meadows as well as Pocono Downs.

“Last year, I stopped going to Hawthorne and started going to Pocono,” Warren said. “I had a couple trainers that wanted to use me, so I did it. I was pretty happy with the results.”

“There are a lot of guys on the East Coast. You kind of have to go where you think you can fit in. I thought I could drive with these guys; I just needed a shot. That’s really what you need in this business, an opportunity.”

Warren plans to make the most of his opportunities and continue to improve as a driver.

“You have to be willing to learn,” Warren said. “I’m a visual learner, so I watch people and see how they do stuff and then try to apply it and try to get better. I’ve learned to be able to help a horse throughout a mile more by being out here and watching different drivers. Harness writers' impact on the game has many facets

When the voters in the State of New York approved a referendum legalizing pari-mutuel wagering in November 1939, it foretold an exciting chapter for horse racing generally and the American-born sport of trotting that took place on country roads in the 1800s.

The New York State Legislature had passed the necessary bill earlier that year for the voters to decide the wagering question. It didn't take long for voter approval to become a reality.

By September 1940, George Morton Levy, a nationally renowned criminal attorney with high profile cases and business associates leased an abandoned track used for auto races and founded Roosevelt Raceway in Long Island, NY. He later became known as the godfather of modern harness racing and the pioneer of night harness racing.

Sportswriters from Long Island newspapers began regularly covering harness racing at the track. On May 8, 1947, 12 of them formed the U.S. Harness Writers Association (USHWA), becoming the organization's charter members.

Being close to the sport's leading figure, they decided then to ask track owner and attorney Levy to draft a certificate of incorporation to make it official. That legal document was filed with the State of New York on July 16, 1947.

There you have it: 12 harness writers formed an association that hit its 75th anniversary in 2022.

USHWA has recognized this milestone throughout 2022 and chosen its annual Dan Patch Awards banquet, presented by Caesar's Entertainment, to celebrate this milestone at the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort in Orlando, FL, keeping with efforts to host the sport's award winners in a first-class atmosphere.

Upon his election in 2022, USHWA president Barry Lefkowitz, whose career included director of public relations at the legendary Roosevelt Raceway, made USHWA's 75th anniversary a priority for his administration.

It has grown into a world-class organization that is the industry's largest group of communicators and the only media organization promoting harness racing, its equine and human participants and leading performers.

From the original 12 writers, the membership grew in numbers and geographically across the country wherever there were harness racetracks and standardbred breeding and training farms to the point that there are currently 12 active membership chapters with 200 members.

In order of their being established, USHWA now has chapters in New York City (1953), Ohio (1956), Monticello-Goshen (1959), New England (1961), Delaware Valley (1963), Florida (1964), Kentucky (1977), New Jersey (1987), Keystone (2006), Upstate New York (2008), Canada (2014), Indiana (2019), and At-Large, a category created for those members who were not in proximity to a racetrack.

The original purpose enunciated in the incorporation papers were "to permit greater interest in the sport of harness racing through creating closer cooperation between writers of the sport and racing officials, trainers, owners and drivers in the harness horse field."

During the past 75 years, USHWA has developed that purpose into a reality by shining the spotlight on the industry's major racing events and the leading participants that keep it going strong.

USHWA members are responsible for voting annually for harness racing's most prestigious awards: Horses of the Year, Living Hall of Fame inductees, Stanley F. Bergstein-Proximity Achievement Award and leading drivers, trainers and other human and equine awards.

One of the first efforts of the organization was recognition of the outstanding horses with the selection of Victory Song as Horse of the Year (1947), an award that now highlights USHWA's annual awards banquet, the first of which was in 1948.

Over a six-year span in the 1960s, two horses won that award three consecutive years and did so back-to-back: Bret Hanover, 1964-66, followed by Nevele Pride, 1967-69.

There were only eight two-time Horse of the Year winners, most notably Good Time in 1949 and 1952 and the only mare, Moni Maker in 1998-99.

The other two-time winners were Mack Lobell (1987-88), Cam Fella (1982-83), Niatross (1979-80), Albatross (1970-71), Adios Butler (1960-61), and Scott Frost (1955-56).

Coincidentally, USHWA's most cherished individual honor, the Bergstein-Proximity Achievement Award, includes the name of the mare Proximity, chosen Horse of the Year in 1950. Proximity also is one of only 14 mares or fillies to be Horse of the Year.

Another unusual coincidence connecting the name of Proximity to the USHWA banquet came in 2018 when Foiled Again, the sport's richest harness horse of all time, was walked into the banquet room in front of hundreds of people to receive the aforementioned Bergstein-Proximity Award and be honored as Pacer of the Year. It was a unique moment in USHWA history when a horse was honored "in person" indoors.

There have also been only six geldings to receive the top equine award, Wiggle It Jiggle It (2015), Gallo Blue Chip (2000) Staying Together (1993), Savoir (1975), Su Mac Lad (1962) and Pronto Don (1951).

USHWA recognizes the best of harness racing's media people with the John Hervey Award for excellence in writing, George Smallsreed Award for photography and Sam McKee Award for broadcasting and votes to elect membership chapter nominees to the Harness Racing Communicators Hall of Fame.

It has also opened the door to future interest in harness racing by creating a youth membership and created a path for budding young journalists to participate in the Clyde Hirt Journalism Workshop on Hambletonian Week at The Meadowlands.

USHWA is involved with the Harness Horse Youth Foundation (HHYF), hosting a silent auction at the Dan Patch Awards banquet that provides funds for HHYF summer camps of hands-on experiences for young people about working with the horses.

Because of its role in voting to induct Hall of Fame honorees, USHWA works closely with the Harness Racing Museum and Hall of Fame in Goshen, NY, makes a direct annual donation and requires its members to become dues-paying members of the Hall of Fame.

What the New York State Legislature did in 1939 to launch pari-mutuel wagering led to the 1947 creation of USHWA by sports writers covering harness racing. In 2022, the New Jersey State Legislature adopted a special commendation recognizing USHWA's 75th anniversary milestone.

Her win in the Sire Stakes final in 1:51.2 was a world record for a 2-year-old filly on a half-mile track. She crowned her season as the 2021 Ohio 2-year-old Pacing Filly of the Year. She had other wins in Kentucky in the Bluegrass Stakes, was the winner of the Next Generation and was second in the Breeders Crown final.

Sea Silk followed that up with an equally impressive 3-year-old season. She swept all four legs of the Ohio Sire Stakes and was second in the Jugette. Ultimately, Sea Silk was on the board 11 times in 14 starts, with eight wins, and she was named the 2022 Ohio 3-year-old Pacing Filly of the Year.

Sea Silk has now been retired to Diamond Creek and will be bred to the fully booked Sweet Lou in 2023.

Natalie Elliott and Jack Wray, both owner/trainers, were the big winners on Saturday (Feb. 25) evening as The Raceway at Western Fair District honored its top performers from the 2022 season in front of a capacity crowd at the Top Of The Fair dining room.

Elliott's Heavy Dude E was awarded the M & T Printing Group Overall Horse of the Year along with top Older Trotting Horse on the strength of a 10-for-37 season in which he banked just shy of \$70,000 while racing primarily at The Raceway.

Veteran Jack Wray took home the most hardware with Greystone Treasurer winning both Older Pacing Mare and Claimer of the Year and his Okeeheelee capturing 3-Year-Old Trotting Filly.

Trainer Lorne House also doubled up as Greystone Ian O was honored as top 3-Year-Old Pacing Colt while Pembroke Legacy N got the nod as top Preferred Pacer.

Tyler Borth and Travis Henry finished in a tie for top driver in 2022, both with 144 wins, while O'Brien Award finalist for Rising Star, Cassidy Schneider, received the award as Trainer of the Year.

It was the first in-person awards night held at The Raceway since 2020.

Big M adds “Prime Time Hi-5” after fabulous February

Effective this Friday (March 3), The Meadowlands will celebrate their own March Mania after an extremely memorable February with the addition of a second 10-cent Hi-5 to one of the most popular wagering menus in racing.

The mile oval will have 14-race programs this Friday and Saturday (March 4) that have a first-race post time of 6:20 p.m.

“Given the fact that we were only offering one Hi-5, or pentafecta, if you prefer, per night, adding a second simply made a lot of sense, since a chunk of our players don’t wait around for the last race,” said track chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. “Now, they can get into a Hi-5 pool in both the seventh race as well as the last race of the night.”

Last weekend (Feb. 24-25), over \$65,000 was pushed through the windows on the Hi-5, and despite favorites winning both races, the payouts were \$702.67 and \$525.81 on Friday and Saturday, respectively.

The “Prime Time Hi-5” will be the seventh wager The Meadowlands offers nightly that has a low takeout of 15 per cent. Each Hi-5 has a low 10-cent minimum wager.

The Big M offers the traditional non-jackpot Hi-5 wager in order to keep the actual takeout at a low 15 per cent for the benefit of the horseplayer.

THE SENSATIONAL SEVEN: These are the seven wagers The Big M offers nightly to the bettor that offer both a low minimum wager as well as a low 15 per cent takeout. In addition, the two Pick-4s offer a guaranteed pool of \$50,000.

The list:

- Race 1: 20-cent Pick-5

- Race 3: 20-cent Survivor Pick-7

- Race 6: Early 50-cent Pick-4 (\$50,000 guaranteed pool)

- Race 7: Early 10-cent Hi-5

- Race 8: 20-cent Pick-6

- Race 10: Late 50-cent Pick-4 (\$50,000 guaranteed pool)

- Race 14: Late 10-cent Hi-5

INCREDIBLE TURNAROUND: The uptick in business when comparing Meadowlands handle during February of 2022 to this year is astounding.

A year ago, there was only one card during the second month of the calendar year that saw wagering top the \$3-million mark. This year, all seven February programs (there was one cancellation) saw betting clear the \$3-million hurdle, which includes the \$3.8 million put in play on Feb. 18, a track — and presumably, industry — 2023 best.

In fact, thus far this year, there have been 15 programs contested on Friday and Saturday nights and each one has seen wagering go past the \$3-million mark.

Average nightly handle during February of 2022 was \$2.77 million, while this year, that number was \$3.38 million, an increase of over \$600,000 per night.

“The loyal support of Gov. (Phil) Murphy, the New Jersey State Legislature, our horsemen and horseplayers around the world has resulted in The Meadowlands being the No. 1 nighttime product in all of racing,” said Settlemoir. “An international audience tunes in every weekend to see a mile track with non-stop action, full fields, large pools, low takeouts and chances galore to make a score.

“Much of our success can be attributed to our competitive racing. The percentage of winning favorites at The Big M is 35, which stacks up well against the top three thoroughbred tracks. Gulfstream, whose favorites win 35 per cent of the time and Santa Anita and Aqueduct, which are both at 33. The Meadowlands offers horseplayers a solid chance to bet a little and win a lot.”

Some of last weekend’s payouts back those words up. On Friday, the Pick-5 returned \$2,615 while the Pick-6 paid \$8,010. Saturday’s big hits came in the Survivor Pick-7 (\$8,767), 11th-race Superfecta (\$11,491), 11th-race Trifecta (\$19,721) and Late Pick-4 (\$11,876).

PICK-6 CARRYOVER: There were no winning tickets sold in the 20-cent Pick-6 last Saturday night, creating a carryover of \$7,627 when the bet is next offered on Friday night’s eighth race.

Since the carryover is not subject to the low 15 percent takeout, in the event there is \$50,000 in “new money” wagered, players will be betting into a negative pool, where those who cash winning tickets will walk away with more than what was wagered.

For those who want to get a head start on their handicapping, they can get free past performances not only for the Pick-6, but for every race of every Meadowlands card by going to playmeadowlands.com.

OH YES, IT'S LADIES' NIGHT: In observance of International Women's Day (which is March 8), The Meadowlands will have some special guests and special events this weekend.

On Friday, Ashley Mailloux, an expert handicapper and interviewer who knows both thoroughbred and standardbred racing, will be Dave Little's guest on the pregame show. Mailloux, who last appeared at The Big M in 2020, will talk about what she's been doing since her last appearance at the mile oval.

Mailloux will give out a Pick-6 ticket after the seventh race replay from the back paddock, from where she will be conducting interviews during the card.

Saturday night, there are 20 female drivers – who will be split into two divisions – competing in the second and fourth races on the card, while Mailloux and the track's Jessica Otten will be downstairs on-set all night long, beginning with the pregame show at 5:45 p.m. and continuing throughout the evening with race-by-race analysis and Pick-4 tickets.

THE RACES KEEP ON COMING: Live racing at The Meadowlands will take place every Friday and Saturday for the next 23 consecutive weeks. Post time is 6:20 p.m., except for the last day of the meeting, Hambletonian Day, Saturday, Aug. 5, when the first race heads to the gate at noon.

Walner's Coach K Hanover coming to Dublin Valley Farms

Coach K Hanover, 2, 1:54.4f (\$160,712) is the former track-record holder at Harrah's Philadelphia who has had to retire from racing and will now begin his new career as a stallion at Dublin Valley Farms in Ohio.

Sired by Walner from the Explosive Matter mare, Chezatter, Coach K Hanover hailed from the Ake Svanstedt stable and was an early-season trotting sensation.

In his first pari-mutuel start, Coach K Hanover wired the field at Pocono Downs in 1:56.1, winning in a romp by 4¼ lengths.

His next start was in a \$64,800 division of the John Simpson Memorial trot at Harrah's Philadelphia. In that race, Svanstedt sent Coach K Hanover right to the lead and the colt again won in a romp by five open lengths in 1:54.4, rewriting the track record for 2-year-old trotters.

"Coach K was really good gaited, very strong and a talented trotter with a lot of speed," trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt said.

Coach K Hanover would make just three more starts in his career. In his final start, despite making a break at the half-mile pole, he was a game second-place finisher in the \$413,600 Valley Victory trot at The Meadowlands, losing by just a half-length to Fast As The Wind in 1:53.2.

"I felt Coach K had what it takes to be a top horse," said co-owner Jeff Gural of the Young Guns Stable. "He got a late start at 2 and lowered Captain Corey's track record at Philly (1:54.4) leading all the way in just his second career start.

"We brought him to The Meadowlands in November where he cut the mile in 1:55 to get beat a head in the Kindergarten final before an eventful second in the 1:53.2 Valley Victory. Both races he could have won with any luck."

After his race in the Valley Victory, Coach K Hanover injured himself and was unable to get back to the races.

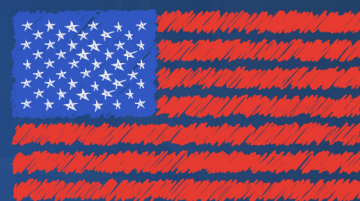
