Equine Welfare and Safety Act could lead to death of racing in California

Tidbits: The newly proposed Equine Welfare and Safety Act ([full story here](#)) in the state of California, if it passes, will be a stepping stone to the death of racing in the Golden State. Why can't the public realize the s - - - t storm caused by all the fatalities was an anomaly? There has been fabulous racing in the state for well over 100 years and now this ridiculous over reaction threatens the entire industry.

Some of the proposals in the bill are totally off the wall.

The first is a provision for an on track pharmacy that would only carry a group of approved drugs. The vet trucks would not be allowed to carry any drug or supplement not found in the track pharmacy. Also there must be a CT scan available 24/7 on the track. Where would the money come from to put these suggestions to work?

It gets worse. Three strikes and you're out. Any trainer receiving three positive tests is suspended. The positives don't necessarily all have to be in the state of California, it is cumulative.

To me, the worst of all is if a horse was to die while in a trainer's care, the trainer is automatically suspended until there is a thorough investigation. Only God knows how long that could drag on for.

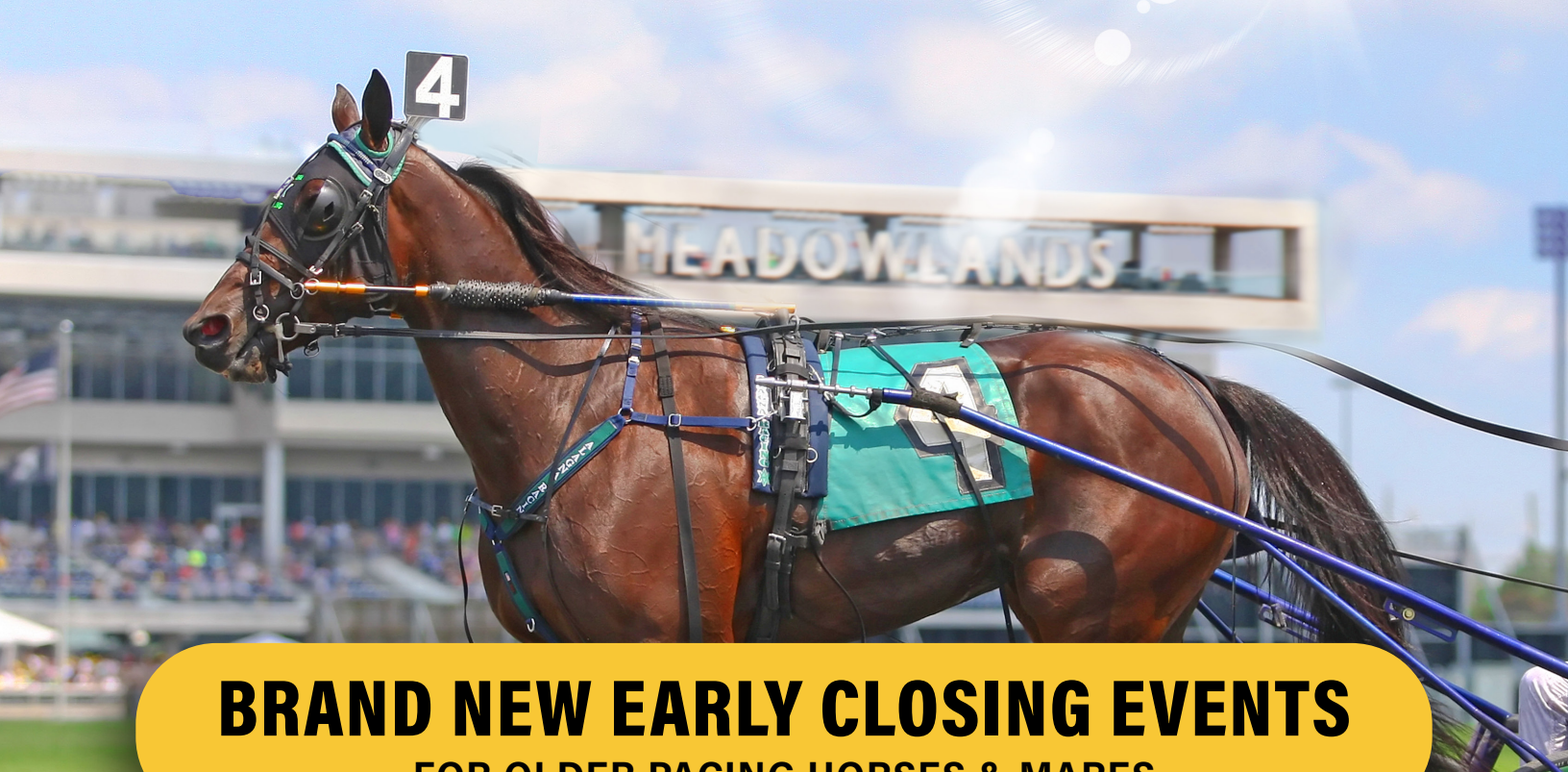

Add to that all three horses came off horrid races in the Stanley Dancer or the Beacon Course as it was previously called.

More brutal was the total meltdown of Act Of Grace causing numerous recalls in the 1996 edition with Continentalvictory.

There is a surreal feeling that I would say lasts maybe a half hour at the most. However, the thrill of victory stays with you forever.

There are moments when you are not sure you know where you are and are totally oblivious to the people around you.

I had one of those weird experiences during the 1992 Breeders Crown at Pompano Park. I had won two Crowns in 25 minutes with both 3-year-old trotters – the colt Baltic Striker and the filly Imperfection.

About a week after the event I met an old friend and said, 'Wow, it's been so long since I have seen you.' She looked at me in a quizzical fashion saying, "Ronnie I drove you to the winner's circle from the paddock in a golf cart after both Breeders Crowns."

Did I ever feel stupid.

It just goes to show you what a total out of body (and mind) the experience delivers.

Filip Van Hauwermeiren (Star Breeding, Belgium) asks: I see that you were the trainer of Boardwalk Hall. He performed well in Norway before we brought him to our farm in Belgium where he is a leading sire. What can you tell me about him?

Boardwalk Hall was, to me, the best looking Conway Hall colt I had ever seen.

He topped Walnut Hall's sale in 2004 at \$160,000. He was also one of my dumbest mistakes. Many times in my career I loved a colt and convinced myself that he could overcome a fault that was staring me in the face.

Boardwalk Hall had corrective surgery on both knees as a weanling. The knees were ugly, but the colt could trot like hell. There were very few colts I liked that year and, along with a very small Self Possessed colt, he was my favorite. Mr. Leavitt sold his consignment at the end of the sale and had one entire evening to himself. Therefore, I had to wait till the bitter end to await my misfortune.

I won't cry over spilt milk. The colt never stayed sound for any length of time and won the majority of his \$120,000 in a six week period during his 3-year-old year. He won the Review in Springfield in 1:53 and got money in the World Trotting Derby (4th) and the Old Oaken Bucket (3rd).

Looking back, I never should have raised my hand. However, it wasn't the first time and certainly not the last time I would make a mistake.

I am glad that you are happy with him as a stallion and when you look to replace him I am available for consultation.

Richard Huston asks: I know you are a big fan of Greenshoe. Now that he is retired for many months, looking back would you as a trainer have done anything different?

This is not the first time I have answered this question. Greenshoe was a very difficult colt to train with amazing ability.

Stefan Melander is only 27 and one would not expect him to be Jimmy Takter at this point in his life and he (in this writer's opinion) made the same mistake twice.

I really believe he under-raced this colt and it cost him the Hambletonian and the Breeders Crown. In both instances there were close to three weeks between starts. I don't care how much he trained the colt, it doesn't make him as tired as an actual race and that is what he needed. One the other hand, put yourself in Melander's shoes. Every time Greenshoe

put his nose on the gate, Melander lost a bit of his life and gained a few early gray hairs. It must have been torture watching the fractious colt bob and weave and throw his head. Poor Brian Sears, one trip behind Greenshoe was like 10 behind a normal colt.

Now people will tell me that this is the new breed of horse and being more like the thoroughbred they shouldn't be raced as often. I agree 100 per cent. However, this horse presented a myriad of bad habits and was ultra-hyper and deserved to be treated as an exception.

Looking back, I don't understand one thing, and I hope "Baby Trainer" doesn't get angry with me. Greenshoe was way too fresh with the long layoff before the Hambletonian and proved to be an impossible handful in the race. Why did they make the same mistake in the Breeders Crown?

Brad Grant on why he ponied up for a Mohawk Million slot

After announcing last month that all nine slots had filled as a pre-requisite for the inaugural Mohawk Million to take place Sept. 26 as scheduled, Woodbine revealed Thursday the names of the owners of the slots. As expected, the list of slot holders includes some of the most prominent owners, many with deep and longstanding ties and contributions to the sport.

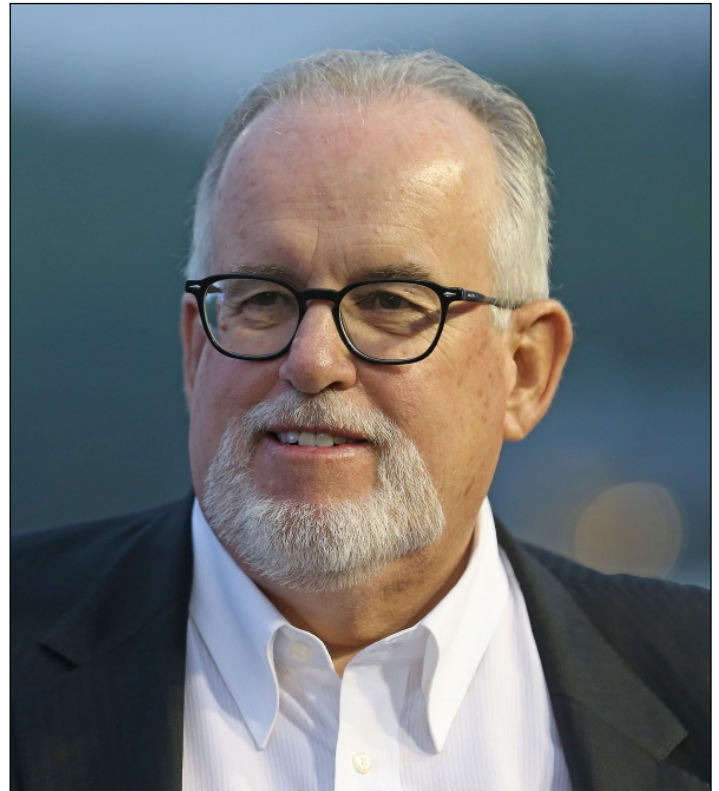
Among those individuals is Ontario resident Brad Grant. One of the largest owners, Grant won the Hambletonian in 2018 as part of Atlanta's ownership and also won two legs of the pacing Triple Crown that same year with Stay Hungry. As one of the larger investors in younger horses, Grant now has his eyes on the Mohawk Million.

To have a realistic chance to compete in the race, a combination of both quantity and quality of young horses is required, of which Grant holds both. In making his decision to go all-in for the race, Grant said, "I think one of the things, obviously, is that we think we have some nice colts including Maverick, the one we paid a lot of money for."

In Maverick, the full brother to champion Greenshoe, a group including Grant paid a harness racing record \$1.1 million for Maverick at last year's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

In addition to Maverick, Grant said he is confident that other colts show similar early promise.

"Cash Hudson (a Crawford Farms-bred Chapter Seven) is another good colt that I was able to buy into and own with Al and Michelle Crawford. I've also got Roberts Hanover (\$45,000 yearling from the family of Muscle Hill) who is going very well. We think we have a few – again, everybody looks great at this time of year – but I'm really just hoping that's a contender from them at that time that are good enough to be in it. I'm keeping my fingers crossed."



Claus Andersen

Owner Brad Grant (after winning the 2019 Armbro Flight with Atlanta at Woodbine Mohawk Park) said he bought a slot in the Mohawk Million because he has a number of promising young trotters and because it "was a great opportunity to support our industry."

Even with a million-dollar yearling and an arsenal of other talented young trotters, it's still a tough call financially to put up \$110,000 not knowing fully what you have and not knowing what horses you'll be competing against months from now. But for Grant and probably all others, the decision to buy into the Mohawk Million was strictly about dollars and cents.

"I think it's a great race for the industry," said Grant. I think Jessica Buckley at Woodbine Mohawk have really ramped up and stepped to do something out of the norm. I know that John (Campbell) had tried to do the race in the States and at that time I supported his efforts and I just kind of thought this was a great opportunity to support our industry."

Grant said there are other reasons the race appealed to him.

"It's right in my backyard. Woodbine Mohawk is doing so much to promote the business, promote the entertainment, get new people in, and I think that if you look at the people that have bought positions in that race, I mean, they're all people that want to see this business grow and flourish. Obviously, Mr. (Anders) Strom has had tremendous luck with trotters, Mr. (Serge) Godin has continually, in the last number of years, gotten stronger and stronger on the trotting side. Adam (Bowden) has done a great job, and with Fashion Farms and Mr. (Jules) Siegel, what can you say? He's a legend. Mr. (Jeffery) Snyder and Jim Bullock, who's been a long-time horseperson, still believes in (the game) and still thinks he can get there. I think we're all hoping as well as having horses there that it turns out to be a great event."

With the Mohawk Million now solidified, all eyes in the harness racing world will turn to Woodbine Mohawk Park in September. In addition to the Mohawk Million, the Metro Pace – the premier Canadian race for 2-year-old pacers – will take place on the same card, as well the She's A Great Lady for 2-year-old pacing fillies. Prior to Mohawk Million card on Sept. 12 will be the William Wellwood Memorial final, in which the winner of that race will get a free entry into the big race two weeks later.

"The other thing about it, is that the buzz starts now," said Grant. "Everybody on that list, people are going to be watching all these 2-year-olds from them and ask how your 2-year-olds are doing when they start to race. And every trotter – when you talk about the trotters you're going to be talking about the million-dollar race all in the same sentence. For the next number of months until September it's

going to be front and center and get buzz for the industry with what's going to go on up there at that time. You're going to have the best horses there for the Wellwood and then you're going to have the night of the million dollars. You're going to have the best horses at 2-year-old levels and the best drivers in the world there and you keep your fingers crossed that this is the start of something new."

The idea of a million-dollar race for 2-year-old trotters is something that has been in the making for over a couple years and if successful could help propel further excitement.

"I remember two years ago at the Breeders Crown talking to John (Campbell) about it and I told him at that time that I'm in and think it's a great idea. I was disappointed it wasn't able to get off the ground then, but I'm sure with John's support that Jessica and team Woodbine Mohawk were able to get the interest going and, hopefully, it's the start of something big. I mean, how many times a year do we get to race for a million bucks?"

Mohawk Million slot owners revealed

Woodbine Entertainment has revealed the names of the nine slot owners for the inaugural Mohawk Million on Sept. 26 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

A total of nine slots were available for purchase at the cost of \$110,000 (USD) for entry in the Mohawk Million. The deadline to purchase a slot passed on Feb. 18 with all slots sold. The 10th and final slot in the \$1 million (USD) race for 2-year-old trotters will be awarded to the winner of the William Wellwood Memorial on Sept. 12.

The Mohawk Million will become harness racing's richest race for 2-year-olds.

The nine slot owners for the inaugural Mohawk Million are as follows:

The owners of the slots are not required to declare a 2-year-old trotter for the race until entry time (Sept. 22) and the slot is an entity that may be sold, traded or subject to lease.

"As a racetrack operator and industry leader, we can create the opportunity, but without the investment and commitment from leading owners, this exciting event wouldn't be possible," said Jim Lawson, CEO of Woodbine Entertainment. "Thanks again to all of the owners who

purchased a slot."

The Mohawk Million will take place along with the \$850,000 Metro Pace for 2-year-old pacers on Sept. 26, putting the sport's two richest races for freshmen on the same card.

"The month of September at Woodbine Mohawk Park will be must-see racing as we reach the height of our lucrative stakes program," said Lawson. "We take pride in being able to offer industry-leading events and look forward to hosting the best young standardbreds at our facility."

The \$550,000 Shes A Great Lady for 2-year-old pacing fillies will also take place on the Mohawk Million card, which will feature total purses of more than \$2.7 million.

Brad Grant

It's been a tremendous run of success in recent years for Canadian trucking magnate Brad Grant. The Milton, ON resident has led all Woodbine owners in wins since 2016 and has become one of the most prominent and successful owners in the entire sport. Grant was introduced to harness racing by his father John, a member of the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame, who owned a farm and breeding operation in nearby Hornby, ON. Brad followed his father's footsteps by launching his own trucking company, Active Transport, in the 1980s and later purchased John Grant Haulage from his father. Grant's involvement in sports included a successful 15-year run as owner of the Milton Merchants Jr. Hockey Club, winning multiple championships. Grant investment in harness racing has grown since the devastating 2016 Classy Lane Stables barn fire that took his millionaire-pacer Apprentice Hanover. Grant immediately purchased several horses for his trainer, including eventual millionaire Easy Lover Hanover. A major player on the Grand Circuit, Grant has owned superstars such as 2018 Hambletonian champion Atlanta and Breeders Crown winner Stay Hungry. A member of the Milton District Hospital Foundation board of directors, Grant was recognized with the 2019 USHWA Humanitarian Award after using his horse's earnings to raise funds for the Humboldt Broncos bus crash victims.

Courant Inc. (Anders Ström)

The Swedish-born horseman behind Courant Inc. deserves straight A's for his trio of "G's," namely, Gimpanzee (co-owns with SRF Stable), Greenshoe, and Green Manalishi S. Ström's Courant Inc., which teams with individual partners on numerous horses, watched his fearsome threesome trot their way to stardom – with trainer Marcus Melander orchestrating their campaigns – in the 3-year-old colt ranks last year, as they combined to earn over \$3 million in 2019. The trotting titans were three reasons, albeit big ones, behind Courant Inc. receiving 2019 Owner of the Year honours, as selected by the United States Harness Writers' Association. With just 16 starters, Courant and partners posted \$3.9 million in earnings, good enough to place them in the top 10 in the North American rankings. Courant, which recently spent over \$1.6 million at the yearling sales in Lexington and Harrisburg, also remains a major force in Sweden and in France.

Determination (Serge Godin)

Information-technology mogul Serge Godin has enjoyed major success in both the business world and standardbred racing. In 2013, Godin was seeking a private trainer to take over his Determination stable, and opted for conditioner Luc Blais. Last year, the duo celebrated Hambletonian glory when Forbidden Trade took the iconic race, with Bob McClure in the sulky. The son of Kadabra was named Canada's Horse of the Year and Top 3-Year-Old Trotter, both in 2019. The now-retired Intimidate delivered Godin (who co-owned with Judy Farrow) and Blais stirring scores in both the Breeders Crown (2012) and Maple Leaf Trot (2014). Founding the CGI Group in 1976, Godin, in 2016, was elevated from a member of the Order of Canada to an officer.

Diamond Creek's Adam Bowden is one of nine owners that spent \$110,000 (USD) to purchase a slot in the inaugural Mohawk Million set for September at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Diamond Creek Racing (Adam Bowden)

Adam Bowden established Diamond Creek Farm in 2005 at the age of 24, with the vision of creating a breeding operation that focused on influential bloodlines and producing quality horses for the sales ring and racetrack. Introduced to racing by his father and grandfather at a young age, Bowden pursued his passion immediately following graduation from college. Diamond Creek opened for business in Kentucky during the fall of 2005 and expanded its operation to Pennsylvania in 2012. Diamond Creek's racing side has owned multiple champions, including Creatine and Pure Country. The Diamond Creek stallion roster is an impressive collection of superstars, including World Champion pacer Always B Miki and two-time Breeders Crown champion trotter Father Patrick.

Dreamland Farms (Gina Ghent)

Gina Ghent has taken the reins of running the day-to-day operation of Dreamland Farms, a picturesque 105-acre property found in Cream Ridge, NJ. The farm was built nearly 30 years ago by Ghent's uncle and long-time standardbred racing figure, David Molski, a hands-on horse owner and breeder who enjoyed a great passion for the sport. When Molski was killed in a single-car accident in 2007, his wife, Clara, took charge of Dreamland. One of the couple's first broodmares was a Big Towner mare, Breeders Crown champion Hardie Hanover, whom the couple bought at the Standardbred Horse Sale at Harrisburg. After Clara's recent passing, Ghent picked up the torch, determined to carry on the traditions and values associated with the farm. "She

always told me, ‘You’ll know what do,’” said Ghent, of her aunt and godmother. “This was her dreamland.”

Fashion Farms (Jules Siegel)

Hall of Famer Jules Siegel’s Fashion Farms has been a powerhouse in both racing and breeding for multiple decades. A retired pharmacist who operated a successful chain of drug stores, Jules and his late-wife Arlene established Fashion Farms in New Hope, PA in 1984. After selling his drug store chain in 1995, Jules Siegel acquired first-rate broodmares, bred them to top sires to produce successful racehorses, then retained the mares for future breeding, building success upon success. The 1995 Hambletonian champion Tagliabue provided Siegel with his first of many award-winning trotters and pacers, including Galleria, Broadway Hall, Village Jolt, Broadway Schooner and Broadway Donna. Siegel has been recognized with several top honours during his time in racing, including being named the recipient of the United States Harness Writers Association’s Owner of the Year award in 2002 and 2009. Siegel became a member of the U.S. Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 2017.

Glengate Farms (Jim Bullock)

It was over 10 years ago when Jim Bullock shuttered the doors on Glengate Farms as a commercial breeding operation. One of the largest of its kind in Ontario, Glengate was home to all-star stallions Angus Hall, Apaches Farm and Balanced Image. While he remained in the sport after the closure of Glengate, Bullock’s passion for standardbreds and standardbred racing led him to renovate a thoroughbred farm close to the town of Erin, a spot he purchased a few years back, using it to build up a strong trotting broodmare band (there is room on the farm for nearly 40 broodmares). Friend and racing partner John Bax purchased the original Glengate Farm to be closer to Woodbine Mohawk Park. Bullock was president and CEO of Cadillac Fairview Corporation between 1987 and 1993 and held the same title at Laidlaw Inc. from 1993 to 1999. He is also a former board member at Woodbine Entertainment Group.

Jeffrey Snyder

Manhattan-based businessman Jeffrey Snyder is one of harness racing’s most prolific owners, who holds the record for most wins by an owner in Pepsi North America Cup history with four. Snyder’s rise to the top of sport began in 1994 with Horse of the Year Cam’s Card Shark. Never afraid

to make a statement at the yearling sales, Snyder has had tremendous success with high-priced purchases, such as Rocknroll Hanover, Royalflush Hanover, Village Jolt and Well Said. Snyder has also hit the jackpot on multiple occasions with broodmare Michelles Jackpot, who has provided the New York native with homebred champions Michelles Power and Michaels Power.

John Fielding

One of horse racing’s most impactful and accomplished figures, John Fielding grew up in Toronto riding the streetcar with his brother to Greenwood Raceway where their passion for the sport first began. Fielding was introduced to harness racing by his father and owned his first standardbred at just 16. Now, he is one of the highest profile and successful names in harness racing, a two-time owner of the year, whose star pupils include Pinkman, Father Patrick, Shake It Cerry, Maven, and 2018 Hambletonian Oaks winner, \$2.2 million earner, Manchego. Fielding, who has won over 20 Breeders’ Crown races, has also enjoyed success with thoroughbreds. In the late ‘90s, Fielding met standardbred and thoroughbred breeder Fred Hertrich at a standardbred sale at Woodbine. They recorded their first win as breeders in the 2017 Thoroughbred World Championships when ‘TDN Rising Star’ Rushing Fall won the GI Breeders’ Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. Fielding, founder of Array Marketing, a leading global provider of retail merchandising solutions, has been on the board at Woodbine Entertainment Group since 2004, and as a Director since 2015.

Brady Galliers is his family's harness racing trailblazer

The young, up-and-coming driver from Ohio is the first in his clan to make the sport his career.

When Brady Galliers made the decision to join the standardbred ranks, he knew the one person he had to count on to make it a success.

Just over seven years ago, after settling on his career choice, the youngster from Defiance, OH didn't need to be reminded that he had no one, family or otherwise, with links to the harness racing world.

What he did have, however, was steadfast self-determination and unwavering support on the home front.

"I was in high school, and I didn't have any ties whatsoever to this sport," said Galliers. "My family and I would go to the county fair races and harness races together. I always asked my parents if they could buy me a racehorse, and they would always say no. Finally, one time I was asking, and they said, 'Okay... maybe we can try with one.' From there, I knew it was something I wanted to do. But the biggest challenge was not having anyone in the business. That made it – and still makes it – tough getting work as a driver."

Tough, but not impossible.

When he was 16, Galliers earned his license to drive on the Ohio fair circuit, celebrating his first victory at the Putnam County Fair in Ottawa. Two years later, he got his license to compete at pari-mutuel tracks.

Galliers made his rookie debut in 2013, winning three races, along with 12 top-three finishes from 25 starts.

He couldn't have mapped out his first race any better... even if it came on the heels of a nearly-sleepless night.

"I'd say it was probably a nervous energy," said Galliers, of his debut. "I was ready to get on-board and see what I could do with it. I actually went to the prom the night before and

was up all night long, with the after parties and everything... I think I was on two hours sleep. But I woke right up, drove to the matinee and I drove my first horse. I actually ended up winning. It was my only race of the day. It was pretty cool."

Posting nine wins in his sophomore season, that total jumped to 24 – along with 15 training scores – in 2015.

With more success, came more recognition.

The Ohio chapter of U.S. Harness Writers Association named him the 2015 Peter Haughton Memorial Award recipient as the state's rising star horseman.

After a 52-win campaign in 2016, Galliers rhymed off consecutive 74-win campaigns. Last year, he won a career-best 82 races, complemented by 52 trainer triumphs, also a personal high.

He has, in every way, found his happy place.

"Growing up, I played a bunch of sports. In high school, I just concentrated on basketball. But I've always had a love

for horses. I love every kind of farm animal, but my favorite is the horse. I was always competitive in sports at school, so making the decision to be a racehorse driver really was a combination of both things – the competition and horses – that I enjoyed. I fell in love with it instantly and I knew it was exactly what I wanted to do.”

Galliers doesn’t need to be asked if he believes harness racing is a sport.

He answers just before the question is posed.

“Harness racing is definitely a sport. When it comes to basketball, you want to go out with your teammates and get the win. The same thing can be said about racing – you team up with a teammate, the horse, and your goal is to get that win. It’s really the same thing for me. You practice every day with basketball, and you jog your horse every day in preparation for a game or for a race.”

There have been more than few highlights to date, including a mare Galliers didn’t have to pay a cent for, but who paid off handsomely on the racetrack.

“She was unraced and I actually worked her way up, and she won the open a couple of times,” he said of Jackies Rocket, an 8-year-old daughter of American Ideal that he owns. “I had a trotter last year, Insomniac (an 8-year-old son of Crazyed, which Galliers also owns), set a track record of 1:51.4 (at Miami Valley). Last year, I won a couple of claiming series finals. I do have some babies in Florida this winter, and hopefully they turn out okay and maybe get some sires stakes action this summer.”

A combination of practice, preparation and patience has helped Galliers increase his win totals and popularity among Ohio horsepeople.

The 24-year-old is eager to see both trends continue.

“I’ve had more work come way over the years. I guess it’s not going downhill... it’s going uphill like you want it to. I can see myself as kind of in the group now.”

While the driver who wears red, black and white as his colors didn’t have the luxury of any personal ties to harness racing, he does have important people in his corner.

“I don’t really have that backbone, that trainer I can always go to knowing I will get those drives. That’s the biggest challenge for me. What I do have is my family. Nothing would have ever been possible without my family’s support. They’ve followed me ever since day one and they’ve had my back ever since.”

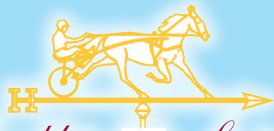

Bazire best in Paris

Top trainer and driver Jean-Michel Bazire experienced another great winter meeting in Paris 2019/2020.

This week, Swedish harness racing media sulkysport.se reported a summary from the winter meeting and nothing much has changed since last year's meeting.

Bazire noted 83 stable victories and his horses earned \$4,158,753 from November until last weekend's end of the massive race program in Paris. Bazire had the record regarding amounts of wins from 2018/2019 and this year he beat that by 12 stable victories. He also sat in the sulky behind 58 of the winners, which put him in second place behind Eric Raffin, who won 69 times in the sulky and 24 in the saddle.

"Our stable had a lot more horses to race this year and we can't look back at any disappointments. Our team has had a great time, we have fun and that things reflects itself on the horses," Bazire told letrot.com when the meeting was over.

Sébastien Guarato's Face Time Bourbon became the best horse of the meeting with \$800,000 in earnings and the Prix d'Amérique winner's owner, Scuderia Bivans Srl, was best in that category.

Ready Cash dominated the stallion's list with 43 wins and \$3,070,285 in earnings which was far more than runner up stallion Prodigious, who noted \$1,144,248 in earnings.

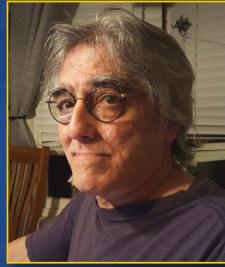

Tracks beware: bettors are impatient between the bets

Alternative Actions (AA) always checks in with pari-mutuel racetracks' activities to attract business. We talk to veteran and novice bettors about their needs and wants when it comes to wagering on horses and, as well, AA scouts the Internet (and what analog publications are still available) for articles written about new concepts in racetrack marketing.

Recently, we read an article published on the USTA website by one of its regular contributors, Bob Carson. His monthly column, titled "Outside the Box," presents "a menu of outlandish proposals" tracks could consider to draw new fans and keep veteran fans wagering on harness racing.

Sound familiar? Sure, Mr. Carson offers ideas, as does AA. We read his columns but have not commented on any of the contents – until now. As a caveat, though, we are not reviewing the particular idea he presented in a column titled "Playing Pods." What came to our attention is Mr. Carson's profile of a gambler that fuels the mechanics of the column's betting gimmick.

Bob wrote, "Gamblers want a thrill, a rush of endorphins, and they are willing to pay for the thrill. Alas, the endorphin rush for a horse race is fleeting – a few moments... We do not offer our players the opportunity to marinate in a long season with daily highs and lows followed by a huge crescendo."

Again, we won't comment on Mr. Carson's actual plan, but we do not have a clue where he found his demographic for it. The misnomer should be obvious to track administrations and it certainly is to my decades of experience with bettors at tracks on both sides of the pond – there is not and there will never be a person who plays the horses who says something like this:

"Geez, I sure wish there was more time between races."

Bob is correct about the lure of "action." Bettors seek thrills for their money, "a rush of endorphins." What they do not want is an abundance of time between races. It's bad enough on most if they get shut out or have to pass on betting a race. Believe it or not, this is especially true for new bettors.

Harness tracks, though, have been addressing the issue. I have taken many people to the races for their first visit.

What I noticed over time is how bored they become at thoroughbred programs. After two or three races, if that many, first-time visitors to a thoroughbred program always subtly ask some things like:

"So how many races are there?" (Even though they bought a program.)

"Do you usually stay until the last race?" (Hint, hint.)

"How good is the restaurant at this track?"

Sometimes they begin a conversation that has nothing to do with the racing, as if they were interested in whatever topic they present. Other times they ask for a tour of the track to pass the time between races because for the novice, waiting on the next race is like being in a dentist's crowded waiting room; time literally slows to a torturous pace.

It has never been anywhere near that bad introducing people to harness racing because harness tracks have closed the eternal waiting period between races, to their credit, and it no doubt helped business. Still, between races you will usually hear one complaint: "What's holding up this race?"

There are many veteran pari-mutuels bettors, though few true professionals, but they have always expressed their experiences in the same vein – that thoroughbred racing dips, drags and dangles between races. The pro bettors I knew, myself included at various times, did much of their handicapping well before arriving at the track, so even what time spent between harness races proved to be tiresome.

Our contention with Mr. Carson's profile of a bettor only brings us back to what AA insisted from the onset of our HRU columns – it is imperative for racetrack administrations to understand their patrons by reducing their traits to its least common denominator.

I have experienced the gamut of emotions betting on all breeds at North American pari-mutuel racetracks, as well as with licensed bookies and with "the tote" on thoroughbreds in Great Britain. At times I had two jobs, the main one campaigning a \$10,000 wagering bankroll. Other times, betting horses was my sole job and I played with food and rent money. Still other times I wagered casually and socially.

However, unlike many others, I learned from the hard and good times that there was always too much time between the next win or the next loss, so too many noradrenalines were ignited and the endorphin thrills turned to wildly random thoughts and bettors become absorbed with enough anxiety to make their limbs go cold and blood pressure rises.

Racetrack managements must be extremely aware that their betting attendance is without desire for "the opportunity to marinate in a long season with daily highs and lows," even if that might be "followed by a huge crescendo."

Caviart Ally ready to resume rivalry with Shartin N

Caviart Ally finished last season with a flourish and owner Buck Chaffee said he hopes his mare can continue her winning ways when her 2020 campaign begins Friday at The Meadowlands.

A 6-year-old pacer, Caviart Ally closed last season by winning four of her final five races, with three of the victories coming over eventual Horse of the Year honoree Shartin N. Caviart Ally's triumphs during that stretch came in the TVG Series championship for older female pacers, Breeders Crown, Allerge and Milton.

She makes her seasonal debut in tonight's \$30,000 preferred for fillies and mares at The Big M, where she is the 3-1 morning-line favorite from post eight in a field of eight. She prepped for the start with two qualifiers, winning the second this past weekend in 1:52.3 with regular driver Andy McCarthy.

"We're very hopeful she can pick up where she left off," said Chaffee, who owns Caviart Ally with his wife Judy under the Caviart Farms stable banner. "Andy said that when he qualified her, he didn't even ask her to go, she just wanted to go by herself. That's been the way she's been pretty much all along. She just really tries and wants to do it.

"Physically, I always thought she looked like a linebacker. And she's always had that desire, which I think has been a real plus for her."

Caviart Ally, by Bettor's Delight out of Allamerican Cool, has won 25 of 72 career races and \$1.82 million. She was trained by Noel Daley at ages 2 through 4 before heading to Brett Pelling's stable when Daley took a year in Australia. Pelling believes he has a good understanding of Caviart Ally as she begins her second season with him.

"I brought her back a little different than last year," Pelling said. "I think she's one of those mares that likes you to push the buttons and likes to work. If you let her have a bit of a vacation, it rears up in your face. She really showed us that. I've got a pretty good handle now on everything that makes her tick."

Following this week's start, Caviart Ally will head to the six-week Blue Chip Matchmaker Series at Yonkers Raceway. It

will be the mare's first appearance in the Matchmaker, which has been won each of the past two years by Shartin N.

"She's 6 now, so there is no (concern about the) age thing," Pelling said. "There's no hiding from anyone. That's why we're in the Matchmaker. She's 6 and she's here to go race."

Caviart Ally and Shartin N finished 1-2 in eight races last year, with Shartin N winning five. The emergence of their rivalry, which produced memorable finishes in the Betsy Ross and TVG final, was a big reason the Chaffees decided to race again this season rather than send Caviart Ally to motherhood. Shartin N got her season off to a winning start Wednesday with a 1:50 score in the fillies-and-mares invitational at Dover Downs.

"I think it's great," Buck Chaffee said. "We had always said we were going to quit with her and breed her, that's always been our plan. But when she raced so good at the end of the year and that rivalry really kicked in, we decided that we had to bring her back. The sport needs rivalry. I think it's exciting. Hopefully it's the right decision."

Ryan Stahl scores 5,000th career driving win

Ryan Stahl scored the 5,000th win of his driving career aboard Crowntime Pet in MGM Northfield Park's opening race on Tuesday (March 3), despite being parked the entire mile.

Crowntime Pet posted a ½-length advantage over his closest rival in 1:56.2. That margin was sufficient to return \$51.20 to win.

Stahl's richest win came in a \$250,000 Ohio Sire Stakes Final with Mission Accepted. It was the largest of the seven Sire Stakes Champions Stahl has driven.

The native of Republic, OH rates the best horse he has ever

driven as being Hypnotic Blue Chip, in the 2011 Battle of Lake Erie.

The 41-year-old Stahl won his first race in 1994 aboard a trotting filly named Lojos Sharp Baby, at the Oak Harbor (Ohio) Fairgrounds.

Ryan Stahl currently holds the track record over the Flying Turns for freshman trotting geldings with Yes in 1:53.1.

Stahl started driving at the age of 14 and appreciates the success he has had so far; accomplishing the 5,000-win milestone and having driven the winners of over \$24 million.

Ryan's career was heavily shaped by his father Lee.

"It is only fitting that I won this milestone on what would be dad's birthday," said Stahl.

Ryan Stahl also credits Gerald Bookmyer, who was recently inducted into the Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Fame, as being a big influence and a great friend throughout his career.

"There are so many people to thank for the success I have had," said Stahl. "My mom, my wife, Kent Sherman and many, many other trainers."

Stahl has been married for almost five years to Nichole. The couple has two children, a son Owen, and daughter Sonny. The Stahl family resides on an 80-acre farm in Seneca County, OH.

Down Under speedster Majordan to race in North America

Majordan, Australasia's all-time record holder of most wins in 1:50 and under (six), and a starter in this weekend's Australian \$1 million Miracle Mile has had a 50 per cent interest purchased by new North American investors Ned Hodgkinson and Milton Leeman and the 7-year-old multiple Group 1 gelding will be off to the Virgil Morgan Jr. barn in Ohio within the month.

Fresh off a scintillating, front end, track record setting mile of 1:50.7, last half of :53.5, in last week's Group 1 Australian \$100,000 Newcastle Mile, the Kevin Pizzuto trained champion — already owned by North American cousins Gordon Banks and Marc Hanover, has been saddled with the 8 post in Australia's biggest harness purse event. With Lochinvar Art, the pre-draw favorite, drawing the 7 post, fireworks may be in the offing.

Majordan should surpass \$500,000 (Australian) in lifetime earnings in the Mile, and has been staked to \$2.5 million

(U.S.) worth of top North American stake races for 2020. The noted speedster, a mile specialist, should suit North American racing time to a tee.

Big M assurances guarantee big action

As the saying goes: “In this world, nothing can be said to be certain, except death and taxes.”

But at the Meadowlands, there are exceptions to that rule.

For Big M bettors, guarantees have been part of the landscape for some time now, and pending regulatory approval, one already in play is about to get sweeter, while another is brand new.

Beginning tonight (March 6, post time 6:55 p.m.), the Big M will offer three popular multi-leg wagers with guaranteed pools that total \$130,000. They are:

- The 20-cent Pick-5 (race one), which will now have a \$40,000 guaranteed pool, up 60 per cent from the \$25,000 promise it had previously.
- The track’s “signature” wager, the Early 50-cent Pick-4 (race six), whose \$50,000 guarantee remains unchanged.
- The new Late 50-cent Pick-4 (race 10), which is off to an incredible start in its first four weeks, will now go from no guarantee to a \$40,000 assurance

“This is an enormous step for not only the Meadowlands, but for the sport of harness racing,” said Big M chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir. “Making the game better for horseplayers has to be a major part of the equation for this sport to flourish. Our fans around the world have responded positively to our new wagering menu, and we are responding to our horseplayers with \$130,000 in nightly guarantees, big carryover pools and multi-leg wagers that offer a low takeout of 15 percent.”

It appears the call by Big M management to shakeup the wagering format four weeks ago was the right one, based on last weekend’s returns. After Friday’s (Feb. 28) handle reached \$2,970,735 – third best of 2020 – the very next night that number was eclipsed when \$2,973,673 was pushed through the windows.

The weekend total of \$5,944,408 and per race average (for the 26 races) of \$228,631 both established seasonal bests.

The guarantee of the Pick-5 pool appears to be one that will be surpassed rather easily, even with the increase. The wager has seen all eight of its pools exceed \$55,000 since it

was updated to use a base wager of 20 cents, with the last three reaching at least \$72,000.

Last weekend’s payoffs were certain to put a smile on winner’s faces, as they cashed in for \$2,092 on Friday and \$3,140 on Saturday.

The consistent play in the Early Pick-4 has seen seven straight pools of \$70,000 or more, while going past \$80,000 on four occasions. One could argue the biggest surprise has been the popularity of the Late Pick-4, which has seen wagering of at least \$70,000 in its last four tries, including a bet-best \$86,834 last Saturday. This for a wager that did not exist until Feb. 7.

The only one of the Big M’s “Fab Four” wagers not to offer a guarantee is the 20-cent Pick-6, but when the bet doesn’t get hit, the ensuing carryover always makes it special. After Friday’s Pick-6 failed to produce any tickets with six winners, \$11,270 carried over to Saturday’s card, when \$77,512 in new money was wagered to create a total pool of \$88,782.

The average Pick-6 payout is a handsome \$4,145.
