# Hall of Fame worthy?

Just based on accomplishments alone, the author argues there are many worthy candidates yet to be enshrined.

(Editor's note: To avoid the misconception that the following people have been overlooked by the industry as candidates for the Hall of Fame in either the U.S., Canada or both, it should be noted that the vast majority of the people mentioned in this column have received serious consideration for enshrinement and it is likely that many will be Hall of Famers at some point. As further clarification, the goal of this column is for Mr. Brown to acknowledge the extraordinary accomplishments of those mentioned, that on the accomplishments alone might warrant them to be worthy of induction into the Hall of Fame. As Mr. Brown states off the top, "the list includes a few who others might think unworthy because of issues, both on and off the track, but features those who in black and white have (reached a high level of achievement) on the racetrack or in the highest places of our industry. I have divided them into three main groups of drivers, trainers and a third category of owners/breeders/builders with a pair in the category of personal legends. I have undoubtedly left off some who qualify and many more who owing to their youth, to these old eyes might not yet be seasoned enough for inclusion.")

#### **Drivers**

**George Brennan** - He's done mostly everything there is to do as a driver — wins, money earned and driving the winners of numerous classics races.

**Lucien Fontaine** - I scratch my head when I think of Loosh not being in either Goshen, or Toronto or both. Virtually all of his contemporaries are there, some of whom, in my opinion only, did not possess the talent nor the accomplishments Fontaine achieved.

**Gilles Gendron -** Look at his numbers. Many out there today might not be familiar with him. I'll quote my dear friend Michel Lachance who raced against him for many years: "Gilles Gendron was not a good driver. Gilles Gendron was a great driver."

**Yannick Gingras** - Many would say the greatest driver out there today. He has it all in spades, at the highest level — overnights at Yonkers, numerous classics and Grand Circuit wins and perhaps above all a great mind, both on and off the racetrack.

**Jack Moiseyev** - Jackie Mo has done it all on the highest level. At one time or another, he was won just about everything there is to win. His numbers and money earned are comparable to and greater than most already enshrined.

**Tony Morgan -** This is a man who has won 16,628 races, more than any driver in the history of North American harness racing not named Dave Palone. Some might say "where are his Grand Circuit wins?" But the number of his wins and money earned are certainly enough.

**Luc Ouellette -** A man like Jackie Mo who has done it all at the highest levels. For some reason, time seems to have forgotten both of them. His record says that he is most worthy.

Ben Webster - Excellent numbers both in overnights and

stakes races. There may have been some who could make as much speed as Benny the Whip, but none more. In his prime, he was as good as anybody who ever sat behind a horse.

#### **Trainers**

**Chris Boring -** Long overdue. Another one who, time has apparently chosen to forget. Chris could just as easily be on this list as a driver. He has developed, trained and driven numerous champions. A true gentleman and credit to our sport in so many ways.


Ron Burke - The fact that he is not already in the Hall of Fame defies comprehension. He runs and is part owner of perhaps the most successful stable in harness racing history. Just being in charge of about 300 horses just blows my mind. The fact that he is aware of and oversees the status of each and every one of them is unmatched.

Casie Coleman - Just look at her record. The many champions she has developed, the numerous O'Brien Awards she has garnered as Horseman(woman) of the year. That's more than enough.

**Steve Elliott** - A consummate horseman. If all he did was develop Valley Victory, the breed would be indebted to him, but he has developed numerous other champions on both gaits including Donato Hanover and Well Said.

**Per Eriksson -** Has there been a trainer who has won three Hambletonians that isn't enshrined in Goshen? Very doubtful. Has there ever been a trainer who did so at so young an age? Most definitely not. Per is another of those that time and the committee at Goshen has passed by. It's time to re-evaluate.

**Roger Hammer -** Who? Yes, Roger Hammer. There is and probably never has been anybody quite like Roger. Nobody works harder. He has been active in every facet of the sport. Although he has mostly been prominent in fair racing in

recent years, he also developed, trained and drove Vivid Photo to a win in the Hambletonian. Roger has often been unorthodox in his methods, but gets the job done year after year.

**Richard Moreau** - The leading trainer in Canada and winner of seven consecutive O'Brien Awards should be more than enough to qualify him for entrance.

Brett Pelling - A trainer who has done it all. He has led the trainers standing at The Meadowlands numerous times. He has developed numerous champions year after year. They say you can't go home again, but Brett Pelling did just that. After taking a hiatus to Western Australia for several years, Pelling came back and picked up where he left off developing last year's outstanding 2-year-old pacing colt Papi Rob Hanover.

Ray Schnittker - Like Roger Hammer, sometimes unorthodox in his methods, but Ray gets the job done. Also like Roger, he puts his money where his mouth is. He owns part of a majority of the horses in his stable. He has developed numerous top horses including Hambletonian winner Deweycheatumnhowe. His work as a USTA director and as a proponent for horsemen has been significant.

#### **Owners, Breeders and Builders**

**Frank Antonacci** - From the great family that has produced five Hambletonian winners, Frank has carried the torch that his father Sonny and his cousin Frank started. Not only a great breeder and owner, but one of the finest people it has been my pleasure to have known.

**P. J. "Jack" Baugh -** An individual who time seems to have forgotten. Jack Baugh did much of everything. His Almahurst Farm was one of the most successful breeding farms ever. He was a successful owner, a true Southern gentlemen and one of the very few USTA presidents to not yet be enshrined in Goshen.

John Fielding - A tremendous force both in standardbred and thoroughbred racing. As great an owner, breeder and builder as he is, he is even a greater person. There are few, if any that I've known in my 60-year involvement in harness racing that I love more than my dear friend John.

**Brad Grant -** My personal Owner of the Year for the last three years and arguably the most prominent standardbred owner of the last decade. I have no idea of how many horses Brad has in training, but I know it has to be a great many. He pays the bills on everything from cheap overnighters to the top weekly classes and then is thoroughly invested in young Grand Circuit types. Also, he

signed the ticket on \$1.1 million yearling Maverick. That's without mentioning that he is a great gentleman and a notable philanthropist.

Serge Godin - His wealth and personal achievements are only surpassed by his great humanity and loyalty. Monsieur Godin generally shuns the limelight, but his Determination Stable has always been a great force to be reckoned with at the yearling sales and on the racetrack. Of course he is the owner of last year's Hambletonian winner Forbidden Trade.

The Katz Family - For decades the Three Brothers Stable preceded by their parents Jack and Pearl have been leading owners in the sport. Through the many lean years and in recent years, they breed, buy and race horses. They are well known for their loyalty and generosity.

**David McDuffee** - In my opinion, very long overdue. For decades Dave has been one of the leading owners and builders in the sport. He is a man who genuinely loves the sport and perhaps just as importantly his horses. If a McDuffee horse is scheduled to train at Sunshine Meadows, Dave is out there with his trusty stopwatch. Like me, I sense that he enjoys the days and months leading up to racing almost as much, than he loves seeing them in the winner's circle.

Jeffrey Snyder - For decades Jeff has been one of the

**Russell Williams -** No one belongs more than Russell. His loyalty to the horses is unmatched by anyone. Nobody that I know of has rescued as many standardbreds or has spent as much of his own money and time doing so as Russell Williams.

#### **Personal Legends**

Marcel Dostie - Very few will probably remember his name. But one of the great Canadian harness drivers and trainers. Very few ever ran a stable as well as Marcel. I have always said that he brought me out. If not for him, it's likely that Adrien Miron would never have heard of me, let alone hired me. For better or worse, Marcel was responsible for any success I've enjoyed in this business.

**Geoff Stein -** Taken from us far too soon, my "beau frere" was as sweet and kind a person as I've ever known. If there was one, he was my steadying influence. When I'd go off the wall, he was often there to catch me. Without Geoff and Sonny Antonacci the story of Moni Maker might never have been written. Geoff, supported by Sonny, bought Moni Maker

at three and influenced her move to Jimmy Takter and the driver change to Wally Hennessey. As they say, the rest is history.

### What does Ray say?

(Editor's note: This is the first of a new semi-regular HRU feature where we pick the brain of multi-talented horseman and common-sense sage Ray Schnittker)

Among a list of things eating at Ray Schnittker these days — some we're saving for future issues — is his take on people that grumble about the United States Trotting Association (USTA), which, incidentally, holds its Annual Board of Directors Meeting next weekend in Columbus, OH.

Schnittker, who is a long-time director of both the USTA and the Standardbred Owners Association (SOA) of New York, said, "it ticks me off that everybody bitches (in interviews) about what the USTA should do. I've been a board member of the USTA for probably 15-20 years and been on the SOA of New York at least 10 years... and I've never had anybody call me up and say, 'Ray, we don't like this or we don't like that. When you go to the meeting can you bring this up?' I've never had *anybody* call me. You'd think if you're going to complain all the time in interviews that you would call up your USTA director or your SOA of New York rep or Ontario or wherever and talk to them. I've never had one call."

### Can it really be five years since **Ron Pierce last drove?**

Ron Pierce hung it up for good in 2015 during the first week of March due to neck and back issues that forced him to the sidelines. As it turned out, he never returned to the sulky.

He was the second leading money-winning driver in the sport at that time (\$215,803,884) and had 9,570 wins. He is now number four on the earnings list as Dave Miller and Tim Tetrick have surpassed him.

Hall of Famer Ron Pierce's last drive came five years ago this

Was it really five years ago that he hung up his colors?

"It seems like it was just last year to me. It really does," he said. "Hard to believe time goes by that fast." Now living in Montana, Pierce was reached at the beginning of March at start of a typical day.

"Let's see, I think I'll take a hike for 4-5 hours — that means about 5-8 miles — up and down the coulees. I have my metal detectors. Plus, if I want, I have my gold mining equipment, fishing poles, bow and arrow. I'm set up to do what I want to do. I wouldn't give this up for anything. Life's good."

Still, on the five-year anniversary of his departure from the sport, it seemed fitting to pick Pierce's brain about his career.

#### Would you have raced longer into 2015 IF Sweet Lou had returned for his 6-year-old season?

"No. I was done. It wouldn't have made any difference."

Pierce won 10 in a row with Sweet Lou – six of those in sub-1:48 miles in a row — a record not topped since.


#### Could you be a spokesperson for the sport of harness racing?

"No. I don't express myself well enough to do something like that."

#### Are you still news?

"Just barely."

"I do whenever I can."

#### What do you miss the most?

"Being competitive. Being around guys like Mike Lachance, Cat Manzi and Bill O'Donnell. I remember when I was starting out sitting on the sidelines with Stevie Condren on our coolers with whips in hand watching the other drivers. We both knew WE should be out there. I also miss the top colts and fillies, the stakes races."

#### What don't you miss?

"The travel for one, especially because I did a lot of it. I remember one night at Dover, myself and Corey (Callahan) each had 16 in. It was about 33 degrees, raining very hard with the wind kicking up big time. We had no time to change our colors because every time we went inside we'd have only a minute or so and then have to go right back out. The management didn't work with us, and it was rough. I remember that night I had an 8 hole with a horse wearing flip flops. It wasn't fun at all. No I don't miss any of that."

#### Were you better with a pacer or a trotter?

"A trotter."

# Why don't you ever hear Donato Hanover's name in the discussion of the best trotters of all time?

"He should be in there. He was head and shoulders above his competition (and was the 2007 Horse of the Year). He won a whole bunch in a row, and he was always well within himself. Only in the Kentucky Futurity can I remember stretching him out-the owners wanted to get a good record on him (1:50.1 in the final his lifetime mark). He was a little sick at the end of the year when he got beat in the Breeders Crown, and it's not like he got beat by a nobody, it was Arch Madness."

#### Your first few drives were with...? (First win at Freehold 1975)

"Split Decision, SEP, Snowball N, Yankee Twinkle. For guys like my dad (Don), Ernie Spruce, Art Unger. I didn't take the route that most guys do. When I started, John Campbell was in full swing. I took a different path, traveled all over and it wasn't until 12-15 years later (1990) that I started to really get going. But I wouldn't change anything about that period of time. I really had a good time."

# How important was winning the 1989 Woodrow Wilson with Sam Francisco Ben for you?

"Very important. Horsemen could then see that I could handle myself in that situation; drive top horses. Right around that time I wound up with Casino Cowboy, Prince Ebony and then American Winner. Kelvin Harrison (the trainer of Sam Francisco Ben) sure helped me out back then."

#### Rainbow Blue - need I say anything else?

"So dominant. She and Shady Daisy were by far the best two 3-year-old pacing fillies I ever drove. And it was a good crop that year, too. You could make a mistake with her, like move too early or get out too late, and she would compensate for it and win anyway. I over-raced her a couple of times, but it didn't matter."

We were talking about Stephane Bouchard's record of 11 straight winning drives set in March 2003. How impressive is that to a fellow driver?

"Incredible. I didn't know it actually. Wow. Stephane was a top driver. I remember many times how tough it was to get by him. He not only could make speed, he did it every easily, very naturally."

#### Will you ever open a driving school?

"No, but I have lots to say to the up and coming horsemen. A lot of the advice I got early on from Stanley Dancer and Ernie Spruce wound up helping me a lot — keeping my nose straight, being patient and waiting my turn, things like that."

#### When you were driving, what did you not want to do late in your career?

"I didn't want to finish any way but on my terms. That is not always a guarantee in this business. I had a fear of being in the way, of driving too long, of not being used any more in the bigger races. Staying around too long is what I mean. I wanted to be able to drive and when done be able to take care of myself. Get out and get on with my life. I was able to do that."

No conversation with Ron Pierce can go without a mention of the Somebeachsomewhere-Art Official world record Meadowlands Pace of 2008. A few questions if you don't mind. In 2004, when Smarty Jones was going for the first Triple Crown in 26 years and got beat in the Belmont Stakes, there was a collective moan throughout the sports world. Did you sense a little of that when Somebeachsomewhere suffered his first defeat to you and Art Official? Did you feel even a little bit sad?

"No. not at all. Not with Art Official. With Smarty Jones, ves. But with Art Official, Joe Seekman could not have had him any better. He was in peak condition. I drove the colt the way he felt. No pregame strategy or anything like that. When we got to the half in :51.4, he went right on. At the 5/8ths, he

was still on the bit and wanted more. He told me how to drive him. I was not about to argue with him. Drove him according to how he felt. I do want to say that Paul MacDonell was committed to the front. Like anyone in that situation would have been. He did nothing wrong, he was just a victim of the circumstances. It took a new world record (1:47) to beat him."

### Wendy Ross – publicist, broadcaster, race analyst, outrider and owner

For third generation horsewoman Wendy Ross, it all began with her grandfather Jerry Ross Sr. When he quit his job working in the steel mill in 1965 to train and drive racehorses, it wasn't long before his three sons, Jerry Jr. (Buster), Dan, and Ron followed his footsteps.

"I am very proud to say I come from a long line of full-time horsemen. I was born into the sport and have been professionally involved for the past 18 years. For the past 12 years I've done publicity and television — becoming a race analyst at 24 years old," said Ross.

Born and raised in Northeastern Ohio (near Warren and Youngstown) Wendy's parents were both heavily involved in harness racing.

Father Jerry Jr., was a trainer/driver while her mother, Carol, was outrider at The Meadows and Northfield Park racetracks. Tragically at the young age of 35, Carol died of breast cancer, leaving Buster to raise their two young children: Wendy and her brother Ryan.

Like mother, like daughter, Wendy began outriding when she was 15 years old and trained under Nadine Habke (at Northfield Park) when she was 18. She wanted to do this in honor of her mother — something I'm sure Carol is very proud of.

"I took a job at a new track in 2006 called Tioga Downs and worked there for 11 years. I had the opportunity to ride super horses and made some great saves. Along the way I rode a Breeders Crown in 2010 and two Hambletonians in 2011 and 2012. My career took me around the world twice to Sweden where I rode in the prestigious Elitloppet at Solvalla Raceway. I was ecstatic that they flew my horse there, for there are no outriders in Europe. That meant the world to me," Ross said.

Presently, Ross holds several jobs. She does videos and manages the publicity and social media platforms for the United States Trotting Association, along with Michael Carter.

"In 2008 I began working at the Little Brown Jug. I started out behind the scenes as a stage manager, but when the position opened in 2014 I joined the live simulcast broadcast. Luckily, I was chosen to fill that role.

"Up until then I had been doing TV at The Meadowlands and it was just good luck and good timing. I now just talk and do the winner's circle interviews during the races. I love it and can't believe this will be my seventh year doing it."

Being this busy leaves Ross very little time for anything else, but she still manages being a hands-on-owner.

"I've owned horses since 2006 and have had a lot of nice hard-hitting cheaper claimers that were fun to race. Right now my pride and joy is a trotter named Pittsburgh Hanover.

"I own 50 per cent with the parents of my boyfriend,

trainer/driver Brady Galliers. We purchased him at a very good price in 2018 and he has been so good to us. I also own 25 per cent of an Ohio-bred pacer named Pinemaster who is training back and will qualify soon. I like to own percentages of horses for it's fun to be involved with other people while supporting the sport we love."

Ross has some personal goals for the sport her family has been involved in for more than a half-century.

"My goals for the sport are to help it grow and keep making it more desirable to the people outside of the sport. And try to attract new owners — but most of all, fans. We need to make the sport exciting and continue changing with the times of technology and instant gratification, but not lose the original allure of what made the sport great."

Being a female in the business, Ross believes women have come a long way in what was once a male dominated sport.

"I admire so many females in the business who have set examples for other women and young girls to follow and say, 'I might be a girl, but I can train and run a business just like a man.' Starting with trainers Julie Miller, Joann King, Nancy Takter, Jenn Bongiorno, Anette Lorentzon and Linda Toscano. All these women have talent, class, are business savvy, and have made big splashes in their own way.

"On the publicity end I have to say Heather Vitale and Emily Gaskin make me proud to call them fellow on-air personalities.

"Ashley Tetrick, the wife of top driver Tim, has built up Tetrick Racing on all social media platforms and set a precedent for others to follow, myself included.

"The outriders Kathy Hawk, Sis Arnold, Cindi Johnson, Missy Rothfuss, Ashley Holliday and Tia Shafer who have literally saved lives throughout their careers; and Stacy Cahill — a dear friend who operates two racetracks and is a USTA director. Stacy does things behind the scenes for the sport (more than people know) and is a woman who holds her own, deep in a man's world.

"And last but not least — to all the unsung heroes in the sport — the caretakers who love the horses like they are their own children. They take so much pride in the horses they care for, but sadly are overshadowed."

A near perfect group from Team Zeron had the Chapter Seven—Legal Lady filly **Eliza B** besting **Splash Of Halo** (f Archangel—Life Class), **No Pay No Way** (c Credit Winner—Not A Diva) and **Arlanda** (f Kadabra—Chapter Heaven).

Some very nice 3-year-olds coming back that looked great for Domenico Cecere and Lindy Farm were **Durhamville**, **Capitol Comet**, **Marquis Lafayette** (a real Hambletonian sleeper), **Okolica** and **Sweet Shirley Mae** and the fine filly and Kentucky champion **Gai Waterhouse**, with **Hall It Off** and **Dubai Princess**.

From the Megan Scran stable a very good pair of colts were **Levine** and **Farspeak** by American Ideal and Artspeak, respectively.

Two more nice sets of 2-year-olds from the Alagna barn were both caught in 2:25. The first included **Dahlia Deo** (f Betting Line—Worldly Beauty), **Easyrunner Hanover** (f Captaintreacherous—Easy Go Go), **Fasterthanarumor** (f Captaintreacherous—Scandalous Hanover) and **Three Way Split** (f Captaintreacherous—Take Into Account).

In the second were **Voluptuous** (f Sunshine Beach—Voluminous), **Angel On Earth** (f Artspeak—Heaven Forbid) and **Bump In The Road** (f Sportswriter—Albany Hanover).

The good looking Swan For All colt **Swingforthefences**, a \$100,000 ticket, brings back Lee DeVisser to the racing wars in partnership with David McDuffee of Papi Rob Hanover fame. The colt from the fabulous Sunday Yankee only went a mile in 2:40, but has been in 2:30 previously.

My pal asked the question as we sipped black coffee while sitting on counter stools at the *Hole In One Doughnut Shop*.

"Dude, I may get older, but I'll never be mature."

He sighed and said, "Trey, seriously, let's take inventory as you crawl out of the wreckage of your last racing season."

"Okay,"

"You lost your money?"

"Check."

"You couldn't afford to buy another yearling at the sales."

"Check."

"At this point, you have no horse and no money for racing horses in the year 2020. What do you have to keep your dreams alive?"

"I've got a new plan, I've got enthusiasm, and I've got friends."

I shook my head, "No, this year, I'm working with three friends who are not rich. Let me thumbnail them for you."

"The first is Karaoke Karen. She is a clerk at a law firm. Karen looks a touch like Cher in her just after the Sonny days. She's a bit of a wrecking ball, but she's sweet once you get to know her. She has not had much luck on the romance front. She keeps looking for a Prince on a white horse and winds up with losers in rusty cars. Missing the Love Boat stinks because KK is lively, audacious, and fun. Plus, the lady can sing. She lights it up when she hits the stage on open mic karaoke night at the Soggy Dollar."

"She likes horse racing?"

"Nope. The only one in the trio of my fellow travelers who knows anything about horse racing is Turk Wilson. Turk is a multidimensional addict, a beefy guy with a bullet head. We have been friends since the fourth grade when he gave me my first cigarette while we sat on the top of the monkey bars at Parma Park Elementary School. Turk works as a groom when he's sober. He's smart with horses and knows the business. The problem is he's not dependable."

"You said three."

"I may be the inventor, but the glue that will hold this crazy ship together is Theodore Thomlinson, who I have called TT since the seventh grade. "You will still have costs."

"I have contingency plans — shipping with a pal who races the fair circuit and Turk will help around the barns for feed. There will other details. The idea is that we set up a summer racing schedule on weekends because TT and Karen have jobs.

"What's with the band? You can't expect to get booked at the fairs?"

"Nope, we will be busking. Maybe on the backstretch, in the parking lot, in nearby downtown, behind the pig barn, the sidewalk, who knows, every county fair is different. The Almost Fair Band will roll into town on race day and do the best we can. We play and leave TT's guitar case open for donations, and maybe the horse ekes out a check."

"You can't be serious."

I nodded, "Turk will handle the horse or horses. Hopefully, this will be a purpose to help him with his sobriety. Karen will bat her eyes, make a few calls, and do some schmoozing. Her part is to try to find places we can play without getting arrested. TT will handle the music. I do my job of securing a couple of fair horses and be the swingman."

"That's just loopy. Something will go wrong, or someone will chicken out."

"Very pessimistic attitude coming from the King of Can Do. Dude, how the band holds together will be interesting. We may be a no-hit wonder group. We may fall on our faces. But my friend, life's a gamble, and this summer, we are rolling the dice in coordination with the fair racing schedule. We are practicing a song titled Strange Rivers in TT's basement tomorrow."

"This will never happen. People don't do stuff like this."

"Maybe, maybe not. We are four loose wheels riding on a rickety bus. The person who worries me the most, the one most likely to bail, is TT."

'Why?" He asked.

"TT is normal. He is the only member of this motley crew who does not have much experience making a complete fool of himself in public. Hopefully, the rest of The Almost Fair Band can bring him along."

### Sweet Mr Pinetucky loves Miami Valley

The 6-year-old gelded trotter campaigned by distant cousins Floyd Raber and Lester Raber sits fourth in earnings in the nation among trotters.

Perusing the United States Trotting Association's top performers in the early going of 2020, 6-year-old gelding **Sweet Mr Pinetucky**s is fourth among all trotters ranked by earnings. In eight starts this season, the son of Pinetucky has registered three wins, and has managed to hit the board six times while banking \$55,550. Currently, the gelding is firing on all cylinders at Miami Valley for breeder Floyd Raber and trainer Lester Raber, distant cousins that co-own the horse.

"He's shown at times what he can do if we could ever get him right in a few consecutive starts," said his conditioner after Sweet Mr Pinetucky picked up his third seasonal score March 3 at Miami Valley. "He's just stayed good considerably longer than he has in the past."

Sweet Mr Pinetucky's success in the Buckeye State is not a surprise, particularly over the Miami Valley configuration. As a 2-year-old, the trotter stormed to four victories in his first five starts on the smaller ovals of the Indiana fair circuit. He went on to capture the \$20,000 fair circuit final at the



Indiana State Fair before moving to sires stakes action at Harrah's Hoosier Park. The gelding managed to win one \$25,000 consolation and finished second in another. He finished the season with nine wins in 17 trips behind the gate, earning just over \$48,000 and taking a mark of 1:58.2.

"He was good from the beginning. He's very athletic and a very smart horse. He got a little sore-footed and started hitting his back leg up close to his hock," said Lester. "We couldn't get him to trot clean for a long time, but we finally figured out how he likes to be shod. He's always had a ton of ability; he just had a few bumps along the way."

After a successful 2-year-old campaign, the road ahead was filled with bumps for Sweet Mr Pinetucky. Returning as a sophomore, the trotter did not reach the winner's circle. In fact, over 25 starts at Hoosier Park, he hit the board seven times – four second-place and three third-place finishes – earning checks in 17 outings. The 2018 campaign, his first in the open ranks, produced five wins and 10 on the board finishes in 20 trips, earning the cousins Raber \$40,800. The trotter was inconsistent, though, missing two months of racing in the middle of the summer with the aforementioned

issues. That winter, Lester and Floyd decided to take Sweet Mr Pinetucky to Ohio to race when racing concluded in Indiana.

"Winter racing is kind of new to me. We never raced in Ohio in the winter before last year," Lester said. "He was sharp when Hoosier closed and we just continued on. I don't know, we just didn't quit, and he doesn't seem like he's tired, so we just kept going."

Sweet Mr Pinetucky's 2019 season was not for the faint of heart. Filing in behind the starter on Jan. 5 at Miami Valley, the gelding proceeded to compete at least twice in each month on the calendar, a minimum of three times in every month but January. He finished the year with 42 attempts, collecting five victories and banking \$76,170. In his last start of the year, the \$17,500 open trot at Dayton on Dec. 26, the Indiana-sired veteran raced fourth.

The now 6-year-old carried his 2019 momentum into the New Year with a victory Jan. 7 at Miami Valley. Driven by Trace Tetrick, the homebred captured the \$30,000 open handicap with a lifetime best 1:53.3. Since then, he has finished off the board twice and missed a check only once. With his latest triumph, the gelding pushed his career tally to more than \$250,000 over 112 starts.

"He is so good in the turns, and that one extra turn gives him an advantage over a lot of horses. He's got enough air that he's okay on the long stretch at Hoosier, but I think it's more of an advantage for him that there's an extra turn," Lester said of racing on Miami Valley's five-eighths. Floyd Raber works for the trainer, so he has had the privilege of watching the horse he bred on a daily basis as Sweet Mr Pinetucky developed into the battle tested trotter he is today. The result is especially satisfying for Raber, as he purchased the gelding's granddam, Wooden Stockings, as a sophomore and kept her as a broodmare. He has had success, with Wooden Stockings producing Sweet Stockings, dam of Sweet Mr Pinetucky and a winner of just over \$75,000 in her career. Another product is Blowlowsanta, a gelding he sold as a 2-year-old that went on to earn over \$300,000. Once Sweet Stockings finished her racing career, Floyd Raber added her to the broodmare band. She produced five winners from eight foals, Sweet Mr Pinetucky being the standout.

"He's always been special. From day one he looked just like his mother," the breeder said. "His mother, she was a decent mare. Back in 2000 and 2001, she raced in the open over at Lebanon. She raced every week over there."

Eight starts and just over two months into the season, Sweet Mr Pinetucky is on his way to having a career year. With the bumps in the road behind him, the trotter is making the most of his opportunities, and the cousins are enjoying the sweet fruits of their labor.

"We just take it one day at a time," said Floyd. "Right now, he has stayed fairly sound and he just keeps going. I don't know where he's going to take us."

Just 48 hours after arch-rival – and 2019 Horse of the Year – Shartin N won in 1:50 at Dover Downs in her seasonal debut, Caviart Ally sizzled over a sloppy strip at the Meadowlands Friday night in her first start of 2020, taking the co-featured \$30,000 preferred for pacing fillies and mares in 1:49.4 in rainy and chilly conditions over a sloppy track with a -2 variant.

"I'm very proud of her," said Caviart Ally's trainer Brett Pelling. "She is reasonably fit and race ready, but there's nothing like a race to get her on her game."

Let the rivalry resume.

"Racing Shartin N always presents a dilemma since they both share the same racing style," said Pelling. "No matter what, posts at Yonkers will dictate [when the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series gets underway next week]."

JK American Beauty, spectacular two weeks ago when she won her first start of the year in a lifetime-best 1:50.2, was on the go early and grabbed the top. After taking a brief tuck, Caviart Ally was up after the lead and cleared at the three-eighths before hitting the half in :55.1.

'Ally' was clear of JK American Beauty as Odds On St Lucie inched her way into the fray at three-quarters while first-over, but through the stretch, after some coaxing from driver Andy McCarthy, Caviart Ally hit the wire a safe neck in front of JK American Beauty. Odds On St Lucie was third.

"She was terrific," said McCarthy. "I was hoping to [come from off the pace] but I had to put her in the race. I wanted to give her a good tightener and we were in a bit of a soft bunch, so I figured we had to be close to the front anyway."

Caviart Ally, a 6-year-old daughter of Bettor's Delight—Allamerican Cool who is owned by Caviart Farms, returned \$3.40 to win as the 3-5 public choice. She's now won 26-of-73 lifetime starts and earned \$1,839,516.

ANDY MAC-NIFICENT: Winning one of the features on the

card wasn't enough for McCarthy, who also scored in the \$30,000 preferred for trotters, with Joey Bats, in 1:53.1.

Joey Bats went parked past the quarter but eventually got around a head-strong Muscle Diamond soon thereafter before reaching the half in :55.4.

Pappy Go Go, who along with Joey Bats comprised a power-packed uncoupled 1-2 punch for trainer Andrew Harris, raced fifth to the half before uncorking a burst of speed to get into contention on the far turn, but faded soon thereafter. The pocket-sitting Muscle Diamond took his shot in deep stretch but would come up a neck short. Misslarose finished third but was disqualified and placed last in the field of six for interference. Pappy Go Go finished fourth, then placed third.

"He was good," said McCarthy of Joey Bats. "I think he needs to sit off a helmet, but if I didn't go to the lead tonight, I knew I would have to come first-over. I knew I had to win tonight. I know they staked him up pretty good, so I wanted to make sure he won."

"Joey is just a phenomenal horse who is still developing," said Harris. "I think he has every bit of what it takes to become a stakes winner at some point. Andy Mac just knows how to manage him."

Joey Bats, a 5-year-old gelded son of Holiday Road—JN Daytona who is owned by Scott Dillon, Michele Nelson and Marc Reynolds, returned \$5.20 to win as the 8-5 favorite. He's now won 18-of-58 lifetime outings and earned \$329,962.

Pappy Go Go, who was in search of a fifth straight Meadowlands win, did not bring his best effort. "Pappy was a little disappointing," said Harris. "He's a very talented horse and when he didn't get better position off the gate, in short fields, everyone is protecting. I knew he was going to be stuck with a tough journey."

A LITTLE MORE:Drew Monti, the 25-year-old driver regularly seen on the Buffalo-Batavia circuit, upped his win total at the meeting to 12 after winning three races on the card... All-source handle on the 13-race program totaled \$2,503,586. Wagering has now gone past the \$2.5 million mark in 11 of the last 12 Big M cards.

# Woodbine stakes nominations in; 77 nominated to Pepsi NA Cup

Woodbine Entertainment has released the lists of eligible horses for its 2020 major stakes, including the \$1 million Pepsi North America Cup.

The Pepsi North America Cup, harness racing's richest race for 3-year-old pacers, has attracted 77 nominations, holding steady to last year's 82.

Metro Pace and Breeders Crown champion Tall Dark Stranger leads the list of eligible sophomores on the heels of his O'Brien and Dan Patch Award winning 2-year-old season.

The Pepsi North America Cup list also includes standouts Capt Midnight, Elver Hanover and Papi Rob Hanover.

Eliminations for the Pepsi North America Cup are scheduled for Saturday, June 13 and the \$1 million final will take place the following week on Saturday, June 20.

The stakes have been increased for this year's William Wellwood Memorial, which led to a major spike in nominations. A total of 195 rookie trotters have been made eligible, up from 154 in 2019.

The purse for this year's Wellwood Memorial has been increased to \$610,000 (estimated) and the winner will also receive a slot in the inaugural Mohawk Million (valued at \$110,000). The rich event for 2-year-old trotters will take place on Saturday, Sept. 12, two-weeks prior to the Mohawk Million on Saturday, Sept. 26.

The Metro Pace, harness racing's richest race for 2-year-old pacers, will also take place on Saturday, Sept. 26. The marquee race for rookies has attracted 191 nominations, the same number as 2019.

Another event that saw a notable increase is the Canadian Pacing Derby. A total of 56 older pacers have been nominated to Canada's oldest standardbred stakes race, up from 37 a year ago.

The Maple Leaf Trot received 46 nominations, headlined by international superstar Bold Eagle. The legendary French trotter captured the Breeders Crown last October and could be poised for a return to Woodbine Mohawk Park in 2020.
