

Too many people make that mistake. The idea is to enjoy having a top colt, but sometimes it's hard because where do you draw the line with the money he could earn this year?

Sometimes the buzz about a baby starts off on the training farm months before he or she even races. More often, the offers start rolling in after a start or two and unless your bank account is bottomless and your ego is in a stable zone, it's almost impossible to thoroughly enjoy owning and training a horse that attracts a whole lot of early attention.

What do you do when one of your juveniles in training is just too good? What happens when a horse is so noticeably gifted that what should be a rare pleasure turns into a continuous pressure? Such is the case with a colt by Lazarus N named Voukefalas.

Trainer Michael Russo was not at all daunted by the pressures that fell upon him soon after he and owner Michael Pagonas literally created, from scratch, a very gifted colt named Voukefalas who looked like the real deal on the very first day he was hitched to a cart.

"People noticed him right away," Russo said. "When you have a good baby, there is always someone watching it. That's the way it worked with Voukefalas. He kept going forward and each time he trained there was progress and improvement. More people started calling or coming around. It's always like that when you have a horse who stands out from all the others when you train at a major training farm.

"From a professional angle, it's a thing you have to work around. If you stay in the game long enough, you're going to have a horse that someone else wants. That's just the way it is. Sometimes, it

can be annoying, especially when you get low-balled or hounded by someone who should know better, but it's obviously better to have a young one who draws in interest than having an ordinary baby that nobody even notices."

True, in the world of training down the babies, it's better to be looked over than to be overlooked, but who needs the distraction?

In the case of Voukefalas, it helps that the colt's owner and breeder, Pagonas, shares Russo's stoicism and nonplussed resolve. So far, he's kept his colt and everything that happens in Voukefalas' career is strictly between Russo and Pagonas. Apart from all the offers to buy or buy in, there has been no peripheral or tangential interference. The magic of owning this outstanding juvenile has remained intact.

Not to compare Voukefalas to Niatross, but it's this writer's opinion that Clint Galbraith, as a perfect example, probably had a few moments when he didn't thoroughly enjoy Niatross. Other parties got involved with the greatest thing that happened to Clint and, well, some of the magic got lost. You know, sometimes it's not about the money. It depends on who's buying or who's selling, or both.

Voukefalas isn't Russo's first rodeo by any means, but last year's rumor mill spoke of some humongous offers of money that were promptly dismissed by Pagonas.

As early as May 2022, when most of the freshman trotters or pacers who hadn't already fallen by the wayside were training in or around 2:15, one top driver quipped, "Mike Russo looks like he's sitting on a world champion."

Not long after, Voukefalas went on to easily win the New Jersey Sire Stakes final at The Meadowlands in 1:50.

Approaching the wire, Big M track announcer Ken Warkentin officially anointed the big colt with this final sentence: "Voukefalas was unleashed tonight at 2-1 with Jordan Stratton. Voukefalas toyed with them."

"Unleashed" was the operative word. It was the best word any announcer could have chosen.

Now the offers were huge. Still, Pagonas never blinked about the money, whereas Russo was never in doubt about the horse.

"There was no doubt in my mind that he would win the sire stakes final," Russo said. "Not a shred of doubt. None whatsoever. Even with all my normal trainer's paranoia, I knew he would win that race. It's hard to explain, but I knew he would win easily. He was third in the first two legs, but both times he got stuck behind a horse who was gapping and had to fly home to get those thirds. Ken Warkentin said he was unleashed and that was the truth."

Voukefalas paced home in :26 and :25.1, respectively.

The Russo camp held steady throughout the colt's freshman campaign. Now they're bracing for a 3-year-old campaign that finds Voukefalas bigger, better and, most importantly, eligible

for a lot of big money races. Maybe a stud career is in the cards, as well. With all that in mind, how many buyers will be asking, "How much is that horsey in the window," this year?

"For his 3-year-old season, I'm pointing him towards the Meadowlands Pace, the Jug, Breeders Crown, the sire stakes and a few other things here and there and yeah, people still want to buy him," Russo said.

"A lot of folks are watching him training back. I know they're watching because everyone tells me how great he looks. He has been training alone and he feels good. People who watch talk about him and there's a lot of eyes on him when he's on the training track. I have yet to train him with any company.

"A lot of things have to go right. If he doesn't come back good, he won't be the first horse who didn't."

Russo trained Voukefalas' dam, Inittowinafortune, who he thinks was a super mare, so there's an additional attachment for him because Voukefalas is a homebred.

"I was there from day one," Russo said. "I was there when he was born, but I'm also a professional horse trainer and I would never let sentiment cloud my judgement in making a sound and profitable business decision. Too many people make that mistake. The idea is to enjoy having a top colt, but sometimes it's hard because where do you draw the line with the money he could earn this year?

"It's an awesome feeling to see my years of experience come to life in a horse that everyone wanted to buy last year. Now he's coming back great, and I'll appreciate the people who will want to buy him this year the same way I appreciated them last year because they're people who matter in the business. If he goes on to race great for someone else, I'll never look back with regret. I'll always see him as a horse who will represent me and represent what I can do with a young horse. Like I said, people in racing, people who matter, will know that Voukefalas originated with me and the way I raised and conditioned him from the very start. That could pay dividends to me for years to come."

Put yourself in Russo's shoes or Pagonas' pocket for that matter.

Monies exchanged notwithstanding, it's probably natural for a trainer or owner to feel slighted when they simply have to take the money, but maybe it's better to be left alone and let the chips fall where they may. It's hard enough to pick out a champ from a yearling sale and it's harder still to breed a colt the likes of Voukefalas.


Sometimes, however, you get that proverbial offer you can't refuse.



Again, it's kind of annoying to have a horse everyone wants to buy — a bizarre irony perhaps — but when those buyers of talent stop buying the talent, the game ends.

Keep in mind that out there on some track somewhere a 2-yearold in training is catching the eye of someone who wants to own it. That's just the way it is.







# **Paying it forward**

The Gural Settlemoir Yarock Driving Club gets charitable at The Meadowlands.

Tonight (March 17) the GSY (Gural Settlemoir Yarock) Driving Club will be making their first of several planned Meadowlands' winner's circle charitable donation presentations for 2023.

A check for \$5,000 will be given to representatives of the Purple Haze Standardbred Adoption Program, which was chosen as their inaugural recipient this year.

The GSY's Equine Outreach Fund, over the years, has donated over \$350,000 to various causes, but this is the first time they'll be doing it so visibly.





GSY president Dave Yarock was always reluctant in the past to make such a public showing of their charitable endeavors.

"If we're giving away money, I don't have to tell the whole world that we're giving money away to somebody," Yarock said. "We do it. I do it."

After several people suggested to Yarock that they should do a presentation, as other amateur clubs have done previously, this year he finally acquiesced.

Perhaps part of what helped change Yarock's mind is the fact that many — both inside and outside of the harness world — may not realize how charitable the GSY, and for that matter, all amateur clubs, are.

"We take the yearly membership fees that everybody has to pay to be part of the club plus the 5 per cent drivers' fees donated every week and they go into the Fund," Yarock said.

He also pointed out that monies are raised in many ways for the Equine Outreach Fund, which has certainly been bolstered by all the opportunity that the GSY has been given at The Meadowlands.

Although there will always be naysayers questioning why amateur drivers are given the opportunity to compete at the top track in the world in the first place, Yarock knows that their presence helps the sport in multiple ways.

"One is the active involvement of all these people, these amateur drivers, who now go out and buy horses and bring them [to The Meadowlands] and bring their family there for dinner," Yarock said. "And we support charities, so it's a win-win situation. We're loyal to The Meadowlands. We're here through thick and thin. And they've returned the loyalty to us, so it's been a good partnership."

Last Friday night (March 10), the two GSY races took in the most action on the card, recording the highest and second-highest single-race totals on the night.

Race one, the first GSY race, saw \$339,460 pushed through the windows, while GSY's second dash (race five) brought in \$299,860.

Typically, the races that start The Big M's two nightly Pick-4 wagers, races six and 10, respectively, record the highest handles of the night. However last Friday, those two races took in \$296,827 and \$295,876, respectively, slightly less than the lower of the two GSY events, which did not have the benefit of a high-profile, multi-leg wager to bolster its numbers.

"The public knows what they are getting," Michael Antoniades, The Meadowlands' post-time coordinator said. "There will be a contentious pace to possibly set up for mid-pack or farther-back closers and you have to consider all the horses. Those are the kind of races that are going to generate the most handle."

At The Meadowlands, multi-leg wagers such as the daily double, Pick-5 (both start in race one) or Pick-4 definitely have an effect on the monies taken in for a race.

However, it should be noted that, typically, The Big M's most popular wager throughout the year, is "old reliable," the exacta and the only time on last Friday's card when a pool total was higher than the exacta was in the first leg of the two Pick-4s.

At a track that loves to talk about its handle, and rightfully so, the GSY is certainly earning their keep, by providing full, competitive fields that tend to be unpredictable. The GSY's high handle is likely a result of the low percentage of winning favorites in their races. Favorites win GSY dashes 22 per cent of the time, while non-GSY races are won by the chalk at a 36 per cent rate.

"The GSY has positioned itself and gotten the bettors used to us," Yarock said. "And they're used to something a little different. And now that we've been sort of a mainstay the last few years, we're accepted. We're more enthusiastically bet than other races, so we must be doing something right."

The accomplishments of the GSY at The Meadowlands in recent years have not gone unnoticed with new clubs springing up at other tracks.

"You've got a club in Rosecroft, a club in Ocean Downs," Yarock said. "You've got a club this year opening up in Kentucky at Oak Grove and, hopefully, at the Red Mile as well. This is kind of all an offshoot of the success the GSY club has had at The Meadowlands."

The success of more clubs translates into more charitable donations.

According to Yarock, charities often reach out to the GSY for a donation and he already has a list for future presentations that includes the New Vocations Racehorse Adoption Program and the Standardbred Retirement Foundation.

Winston Churchill once said: "We make a living by what we get. We make a life by what we give." For Yarock, the GSY's partnership with The Meadowlands has given his club a living and therefore it's on them to make a life and give back.

For years, the Equine Outreach Fund's main charitable work was done via scholarships, but that changed when the world was rocked by the COVID-19 pandemic.

"When COVID hit, I said, 'Wait a second, there's so much need out there, so many people suffering, we need to shift our focus a little bit," Yarock said. "That's when I shifted our focus off of scholarships into other types of charitable efforts. If I had more money, I'd give away more money."







# **Counting down the Borgata Pacing Series contenders**

This Monday (March 20) kicks off the 2023 edition of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series at Yonkers Raceway. Of the 37 free-for-all pacers nominated to the stakes series, 32 of them will be in action in the opening leg.

In what looks to be an amazingly competitive group, I'd say that for about a dozen or so horses, being able to earn strong checks based on \$50,000 races a week for five weeks is going to be good enough. For others though, there are even higher expectations.

Counting down from the top 20 contenders, here's my best estimate of how those horses could all shake out:

- **20.** Funatthebeach N/Burnham Boy N: Split the final slot as to not dismiss mention on either of these two. Giving respect to last year's surprise winner, Funatthebeach N leaves a bit to be desired from his last couple of races but we'll see if he can step it up. Was the sports number one ranked horse at one point early last year; trainer Gillis has been strong at Yonkers. Burnham Boy N was all the rage after his debut at The Meadowlands at the end of January; Ryder trainee steps up.
- **19** Ree Two Bee: Most likely on the outside looking in but he was consistent in this series last year, taking home a trio of third-place finishes, a second and a fourth. One of those types that will be in the mix with an inside post, like how it usually goes for him in the Yonkers open handicaps.
- 18 Im Sir Blake A: Consolation winner last year, he finished third in every leg last year except for the opening leg in which he was fourth. He had a strong year overall earning \$200k, finishing up that season with wins in the Hoosier Park opens. Toured the track last week on return at The Meadowlands in first start since September.

- **17.** Belmont Royale N: A newcomer to the series, he raced at a high level all winter long at The Meadowlands for trainer Nifty Norman and set it up last week first over in the open 1 for eventual winner Backstreet Shadow. His lone race at Yonkers came in early February and he was right there in a race that featured other Borgata entrants, a race he was favored in.
- **16** Semi Tough: Rallied belatedly to secure a nice check when finishing third in last year's series final, he went over the \$1-million mark in career earnings with a second-place finish from post 8 two weeks ago at Yonkers. He's routinely a threat in the Yonkers opens against all the usual suspects regardless of the post and figures to make another good account for himself this time around.
- **15** None Bettor A: Now 10-years-old, he's one of the most accomplished Yonkers horses from the past couple of years. Last year's series didn't go as planned for him, but he made up for it with a win here in the Aria Invitational which sent him over the \$1-million career-earnings mark. Qualified easily enough a few days ago at Pocono as one of four Travis Alexander horses in the series.
- **14** Series, he returns to the scene of his 2021 Messenger Stakes win. A 1:47.4 winner last year, he was third in October's Aria Invitational and is another that does his better work on this track. Qualified almost identically to his stablemate, listed above.
- **13** Covered Bridge: Started off well in this series last year when trained by Burke and gave it a pretty good try two back when he tried to stave off Lochinvar Art late. Coasted last out in an easy race leading into this series, could be formidable.
- **12.** Jack's Legend N: Forced the pace battle in last year's final when trained by Josh Green and would have been higher rated in years past than he is now. Never really tried to get into the race last out when making his first start since December, let's see how last year's 1:47.2 winner comes back at age 9.
- **1 1 • Nandolo N:** One of three Shane Tritton horses in the series and all of them rate an overall chance. This one is currently the fastest horse still early in the 2023 season, taking a 1:48.3 mark on one of the Sunday afternoon cards at The Meadowlands in January. A 2022 series finalist, he won two legs last year and was second in two others.
- **10** Backstreet Shadow: Missed this series last year but was a presence two years ago in 2021. A top horse when at his best, he makes his third start on the barn move from King

to Alexander and delivered last out on a golden trip to take The Meadowlands open. Could easily have more to offer than he did in that one start at Yonkers in February, which wasn't bad to start with.

Hemsworth N: This is a big step up for a horse that towards the end of last year was dominating in the non-winners of 8 condition, but he's proved it so far at Pocono and that win last out from post eight against Nicholas Beach (conspicuously not nominated in this series) was a real eye opener. Trainer Bako is Yonkers fourth-leading trainer this year with 22 wins from 94 starts at time of print.

**Soaring Now:** The lone 4-year-old, he beat Mad Max Hanover towards the end of last year in the Jenna's Beach Boy and could be a threat now racing for Noel Daley this year. Swept powerfully by overmatched rivals when making his first start of the year two back at The Meadowlands and took a ton of action last out at Yonkers despite an outside post; seems like he'll be respected.

**Hellabalou:** Two years removed from his magical run in the Adios elimination and final, he returns for the Borgata series after proving too good for rivals in the Northfield and Meadow's opens. Perhaps somewhat of an adjustment year as a 4-year-old last season, this series could be the start of a strong campaign and Burke figures to have him ready.

Jimmy Freight: A world of credit due to this horse that no matter the circumstances, has been able to keep coming back for more. A gutsy horse for sure going for Brett Pelling and Scott Zeron who won here in 1:50.3 as a 3-year-old, there hasn't been anything wrong with his first two races coming back since September at The Meadowlands. Still a small question mark heading into the series, his best would be good enough to give it a go to win it all.

**Anothrmastrpiece:** Perhaps ranked a bit higher than conventional wisdom would say, I think this horse is a legitimate contender. Another Tritton trainee, he battled it out with some of the best going at Yonkers towards the end of September before being put on the shelf and then gave it a great late charge against Leonidas A two weeks ago when making his

first start back. He didn't draw well in his opening leg, but I'd be surprised if he's not heard from throughout the series.

This Is The Plan: Closing in on \$3 million lifetime, he's been one of the sports best free-for-allers over the years. He won this series in 2021 and won multiple legs last year too before getting the worst of it unfortunately in last year's final. Having last raced in TVG Open last November, he hasn't gotten any favors either by landing post eight for his first leg; a race it seems will certainly be used to re-acclimate.

**3.** Leonidas A: His record in this series the past two years is impeccable and last year he won half of his 22 starts, good for over \$400,000 on the season. A former closer-turned-versatile horse, he actually got the trip in last year's final but was outkicked in the end by Funatthebeach N and had to settle for second. There's nothing wrong with his three starts thus far in the Yonkers open handicaps this year and he figures to be in line for another strong showing.

**2** • to disappoint in North America. Well-trained, he's been brilliant thus far and Lauren Tritton has driven him flawlessly. It is too bad he had to scratch along with the other Tritton horses a few weeks ago due to a winter storm as that race would have really given a better read on him from post eight, but so far, he's lived up to the hype. Would make for quite a story if he can continue to keep it going; I think he will.

**1** • Tattoo Artist: If there's one drive that Dexter Dunn would elike to have back from last year, I'm guessing that the Borgata Pacing Series final with this horse would be right up there. Things didn't work out from the rail as the race favorite, but he of course went on to have an extremely successful season going up against the sport's very best all year and ended up with almost \$1 million on the season to show for it. Qualified powerfully most recently at The Meadowlands. Could be the start of another fruitful campaign.

# Opening round of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series drawn

The 2023 edition of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series for free-forallers will begin on Monday night (March 20) at MGM Yonkers Raceway with four \$50,000 divisions on the 12-race program.

Australia's Lochinvar Art tops the first grouping (race three) and drew post five for the wife-husband, driver-trainer tandem of Lauren and Shane Tritton. Lochinvar Art, who earned over \$1 million Down Under, has been victorious in all three of his U.S. appearances thus far, including a 1:51 win at Yonkers on March 6. He'll take on a field that includes an MGM Borgata Pacing Series finalist from a year ago in Jack's Legend N (post seven, driver Matt Kakaley, trainer Travis Alexander).

Jimmy Freight (post two, Scott Zeron, Brett Pelling), a track record holder at Yonkers, returns to Westchester in the second division (race four). Jimmy Freight, who boasts lifetime earnings of over \$1.6 million, won his 2018 Messenger Stakes elimination in 1:50.3, which still stands as the quickest mile by a 3-year-old colt pacer in the oval's history and has a victory and a third in two prep races at The Meadowlands so far this year. His competition includes former Adios champion Hellabalou (post one, Yannick Gingras, Ron Burke) and Backstreet Shadow (post five, Matt Kakaley, Travis Alexander), who won two legs and made the MGM Borgata Pacing Series final in 2021.

As is the case in the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series, the top two finishers from last year's final drew in the same first leg tilt (race six), with champion Funatthebeach N (post five, Jordan Stratton, Jeff Gillis) and runner-up Leonidas A (post seven, Austin Siegelman, Matthew Medeiros) among the eight horses. Funatthebeach N has won four of his seven starts so far in 2023 and Leonidas A has taken back-to-back editions of the open handicap pace at Yonkers.

It's not just a two-horse race, though, as they will meet millionaires None Bettor A (post three, Matt Kakaley, Travis Alexander) and Tattoo Artist (post four, Dexter Dunn, Chris Ryder) and 2021 MGM Borgata Pacing Series victor and \$2.9 million earner This Is The Plan (post eight, Yannick Gingras, Ron Burke).

Nandolo N (post four, Jason Bartlett, Shane Tritton) is harness racing's fastest performer to date this year by virtue of his 1:48.3 tally at The Meadowlands on Jan. 22 and he competes in the

last group on Monday night (race nine). Nandolo N was also an MGM Borgata Pacing Series finalist in 2022 after winning two preliminary legs. He'll lock horns with the likes of 2021 MGM Grand Messenger Stakes champion American Courage (post two, Matt Kakaley, Travis Alexander) and Semi Tough (post three, Yannick Gingras, Ron Burke), who was third in the MGM Borgata Pacing Series final a year ago.

The MGM Borgata Pacing Series continues for five consecutive weeks before a \$200,000-added final estimated to boost the purse to \$500,000 on April 24. That card will also include the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series final and consolation events for both races.

MGM Yonkers Raceway will also offer the MGM Borgata Pacing Series champion a win-and-you're-in opportunity to both the \$200,000 Battle of Lake Erie at MGM Northfield Park on June 10 and the \$200,000 MGM Aria Pace at Yonkers on MGM Yonkers International Trot Day (Sep. 23).

# BLUE CHIP MATCHMAKER SERIES KICKS OFF TONIGHT (FRIDAY) AT YONKERS

The first leg of the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series for pacing mares at Yonkers Raceway was drawn on Monday afternoon (March 13), with a total of 24 entrants necessitating a trio of \$40,000 divisions on Friday night's (March 17) 10-race program.

In the first split (race four), there will be a rematch between Drama Act (post four, driver George Brennan, trainer Ron Burke) and Racine Bell (post seven, Jason Bartlett, Dave Dewhurst), the top two finishers in last year's Blue Chip Matchmaker Series final. Those two also faced off in last Friday night's (March 10) F&M open handicap pace and Drama Act won by a nose in 1:53.1.

Easy To Please (post seven, Jordan Stratton, Cory Stratton), third in last year's Matchmaker final, is among the entrants in Friday's second dash (race five). Easy To Please also checked in behind Drama Act and Racine Bell in that F&M open last Friday. She'll meet up with the likes of Lit De Rose (post three, driver/trainer Pat Lachance), who won a leg of the Matchmaker and was second in the consolation in 2022.

Lucky Artist A (post five, Braxten Boyd, Ricky Bucci) has won two editions of the F&M open handicap pace at Yonkers this year and will look to keep it going in the third division (race eight). She'll face a deep group that includes track-record holder Gotthegreenlight (post two, Dexter Dunn, Nifty Norman), 2022's

Blue Chip Matchmaker Series consolation champion Gia's Surreal (post three, Jason Bartlett, Ed Hart) and another Matchmaker finalist from a year ago in Karma Seelster (post six, Matt Kakaley, Andew Adamczyk).

Preliminary round action in the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series will continue through Friday, April 14 and will conclude with a \$125,000 added final that should go for at least \$250,000 on April 24. # Woodbine's stakes nominations strong for 2023 events

When the Feb. 15 deadline for 2023 stakes nominations rolled around, Woodbine Mohawk Park happily broke with industry trends.

The Standardbred Canada National Racing Statistics report for the latest quarter (Oct. 1 through Dec. 31, 2022) documented a slight decline in average field size in most provinces, in comparison with the same quarter in 2021.

Yet Canada's top track had strong numbers for its 18 signature stakes this year, with half holding steady or improving on 2022 nominations. The \$1 million Pepsi North America Cup showed a year-over-year increase in 3-year-old pacers nominated, improving from 62 to 86, the most colts and geldings since 2010.

Bill McLinchey, Woodbine's director of standardbred racing, said he was pleasantly surprised by the response to the 2023 stakes at Woodbine Mohawk Park, particularly for the North America Cup.

"That's the big one for us," McLinchey said. "That's the one that I'm always most interested in, where that landed after Feb. 15... To see that 86 [horses nominated] pop up, that was certainly a very encouraging number."

Nominations were also up for the \$850,000 Metro Pace (213 2-year-old pacers vs. 180 last year); the \$540,000 She's A Great Lady (175 2-year-old pacing fillies vs. 164); the \$400,000 Peaceful Way (165 2-year-old filly trotters vs. 135); the \$600,000 Canadian Trotting Classic (70 3-year-old trotters this year vs. 57 last year); and the \$450,000 Fan Hanover (64 vs. 51 3-year-old pacing fillies).

There were drops in nominations for two events for young horses this season: the \$375,000 Elegantimage for 3-year-old trotting fillies (57 nominated in 2023 vs. 67 in 2022) and the \$640,000 William Wellwood Memorial for 2-year-old trotters (188 this year vs. 205 last year).

McLinchey said that there was no clear reason for the trends, although "a lot comes down to the scheduling." Successfully hosting the 2022 Breeders Crown may have also made the Campbellville, ON track a destination attractive to more owners and trainers.

"It certainly wouldn't hurt, that's for sure," McLinchey said. "I think that there's a certain level of momentum that comes after having the Breeders Crown, whether it be just eyes on your product or horsemen realizing it's a good spot to race... I hope that participating owners who were here in October did enjoy themselves and felt that it was a spot they wanted to come back and see again in 2023."

The Canadian Pacing Derby (46 nominations) and Maple Leaf Trot (37 nominations) "were down a little bit, but not by an alarming amount," McLinchey said. "It was consistent in the ballpark of where it's been over the last number of years. I think it's important to look not just at the previous year, but at past years, to make sure that your level is staying consistent. You may have a spike one year and then it may be hard to get that level again."

Some standout 2022 performers have been nominated for the WMP open stakes, including Alrajah One IT (6, 1:50.3f; \$1,512,122), scratched from last year's Maple Leaf Trot due to injury; Dan Patch Trotter of the Year Bella Bellini (4, 1:49.4m; \$2,052,600); Dan Patch 3-Year-Old Trotting Filly of the Year Joviality S (1:50.2m; \$1,978,983); and 2021 Canadian Pacing

Derby champ/Dan Patch Older Pacing Horse of the Year Allywag Hanover (5, 1:46.0m; \$1,671,380).

According to McLinchey, their presence didn't deter the owners of rivals.

"We didn't hear much from people, except the locals who took a shot and made that first payment," he said on Wednesday (March 15), the date for the first payment of sustaining fees for WMP stakes. "I think at this point, they'll still take the shot. To nominate, that wouldn't deter them. Maybe as it's time to make that final sustaining payment, which would be May 15, if someone is really on a roll by that point, I could see it, but I think they are still nominating because nobody knows how those horses are going to come back in their 3-year-old year or the next year."

While quantity is important, it's quality that matters most.

"Really what we look at is: Are we getting the top horses?" McLinchey said. "In a race like the North America Cup or the Fan Hanover, are we getting the year-end champions, the 2-year-olds that are now 3? In the end, the high number of nominations is great to see, but you want to make sure you're getting the right ones... that the top connections of that top horse are choosing your race to race in. For myself as a racing fan, I'm excited to see [O'Brien and Dan Patch 2-Year-Old Pacing Colt of the Year] Stockade Seelster [p, 2, 1:49.3s; \$686,268] come back and Confederate [p, 2, 1:49.2m; \$443,700]... I do think we have customers who are pulling those lists to see who's eligible

and hopefully marking their calendars to see that horse race at Mohawk.

"If there's one point I'd like to make, it would be that with all of the increased money in other jurisdictions for sires stakes and open stakes, we were just really happy that our numbers not only held their own but were up. Again, I think it comes down to prestige behind Grand Circuit races and open stakes. It's refreshing to see that people are still coming to Mohawk."

Dana Keyes, whom McLinchey said "handles all of our staking and administrative duties" at Woodbine Mohawk Park, has been busy.

"The administrative part has gone well," McLinchey said. "Now it's just the racing."

McLinchey has good news for anyone wanting to catch the next generation of stars before the WMP stakes season begins.

"There is actually something in the works," he said. "We're looking to have a horsemen's brunch for one of the baby races [dates], more details to come, but it will be one of the Saturday mornings in June. Everyone is welcome to come to baby races to watch live or on livestream."

# Working at Wal-Mart, Lily Cimino got sold on harness racing

It's been less than a year since she joined the standardbred ranks, but Lily Cimino found a way to keep pace from day one.

Her connection to horse racing and horses came through her boyfriend, trainer Christopher Walsh. Although she enjoyed her visits to the farm, barn and to the races, the thought of becoming part of those worlds never crossed her mind.

Until it did.

Last summer, when she was working at a Wal-Mart in her native Pennsylvania, the opportunity to leave retail behind and take on a racing role arose.

"I met Chris and I started going out to the farm just to hang out and eventually, he started teaching me things about the horses," Cimino said. "I was interested in all of it right away. So, when he asked me to work in his barn, I jumped at the chance. I was lucky to catch on pretty quick and I just fell in love with it."

She also fell in love with the equine athletes.

Three in particular immediately come to mind.

"Kingstons Bad Boy was there when I started," Cimino said. "He was such a nice horse when we had him. He was so patient with me. The first time I put a harness on, it probably took me half an hour and he just stood there and was patient and easy going. Indigo Art, who we still have, is another favorite for me. He knows what to do and he never lets us down. He's a total professional all the way through."

The last entry in her beloved trifecta comes in the form of a 3-year-old trotting daughter of Chapter Seven—Morosita Bi.

"A filly, Foxy Joyce, I really love her too," Cimino said. "She's over at my friend Brittany's barn and I met this horse when she was a baby. She was so cute and I just loved petting her. They are so easy to fall in love with. They are all different and have their own personalities and quirks, but they are all great."

Cimino has also embraced the steep learning curve that comes with being new to the sport.

Although she had some trepidation about how she would fare in the barns and beyond, her fascination with horses and horse racing, coupled with a willingness to educate herself about the industry, helped calm any nervousness almost from the outset.

"I had a few butterflies before I started and in the first few days, but I enjoyed it from the first moment, so that made it a lot easier," Cimino said. "I don't want to say it's all easy because it's not. But I wanted to make sure if I was doing this that I really listened and learned. There are so many things I have to learn and I am open to that 100 per cent. I think it was easier than

Cimino, who hails from Dallas, PA, is grateful for the ability to do a little bit of everything on any given day.

She certainly doesn't miss those times in retail.

"I do a little bit of everything," Cimino said. "I do stalls, feed, their feet, groom them, bathe them, make sure they are clean, happy and ready to go. They're so happy to see you and that makes you feel so lucky. I always make sure I have my carrots for them and that they always get their pats."

As for the most treasured part of her job, Cimino points to the moments when the only thing left at the end of a mile is getting a picture taken.

"I love seeing the horses win," Cimino said. "That walk over to the winner's circle is a great feeling. That's my favorite part. I think some of them can sense when they've won and I know it gets my adrenaline going too. It's a great feeling."

While Cimino is more reserved, at least outwardly, Walsh, she noted, can be far more demonstrative, especially verbally once the field turns for home.

Her mind, however, is undoubtedly racing, as the wire draws closer.

"Chris' mother, 'Weez,' is the loudest during races," Cimino said. "She starts yelling the second the starter car begins moving until the second the race is over. I'm calmer than Chris is. I watch it and everything is running through my head. Chris is more vocal than I am for sure. He is definitely loud when they're coming down the lane and we have a chance to win."

Although they react differently in those situations, the couple is no doubt on the same page the moment they walk into the barn in the early morning hours.

"We get along great," Cimino said. "I don't know how to explain it, other than that we respect what the other one does and how

they go about it. He always supports me and is always willing to answer any questions I have. I didn't know how much there was to it, just the ups and downs of racing before I started. The people that work in racing are so passionate about it and work so hard and have to find a way to deal with all of those highs and lows. Seeing it from the inside gives you a whole new level of respect for everyone. Fortunately, we have our own system down pat, which makes things run smoothly every day."

That doesn't mean, however, that things don't get competitive between the two.

Just not at the racetrack.

"We like to go shoot pool with our friends," Cimino said. "It gets competitive. We're both like that. Chris is definitely better, but I don't admit that, so I'll say it's me. Our busy days are normally the weekends, so it's definitely not a 9-to-5 job. But that's fine with me. I enjoy it and it doesn't really feel like you're at work."

This year, Cimino would like to add a new skillset to her racing repertoire, a way to expand her contributions to the stable while also strengthening her bond with the horses.

Sitting behind a horse or two, she shared, would be a big thrill.

"I want to learn how to jog a horse," Cimino said. "That is something I'm hoping for. Hopefully, I will be able to do that in the summer. That would make me happy."

For now, keeping the dialogue going with the pacers and trotters will have to suffice.

And that is perfectly fine for Cimino.

"I always talk to them," she said. "They always listen too, so it's a great relationship."





# Rosecroft opportunities help drive Ahle

Prior to this past December, Johnathan Ahle had never driven at Rosecroft Raceway. This year, the Maryland oval has become something of a home away from home.

Ahle, who lives in New Jersey, is third in wins among drivers at Rosecroft, where his total of 23 is two behind second-place Russell Foster. He also is third among the track's regulars in win percentage, clicking at a nearly 17-per cent clip.

His performance at Rosecroft has helped the 26-year-old Ahle get his second full season in the sulky off to a strong start. Overall, he has posted 37 victories this year and is rapidly approaching his total of 45 wins for all of 2022.

In addition to driving at Rosecroft, Ahle has competed primarily at Freehold Raceway and The Meadowlands this season. He is tied for seventh in wins at Freehold, where his 14.5-per cent victory rate is fifth among regulars.

"I didn't think I would be this far along so quickly," Ahle said. "I'm more than pleased, for sure. I'm just going to try to keep doing what I'm doing and hope things go for the best."

Ahle first visited Rosecroft in mid-December as part of the inaugural Rosecroft-Freehold Drivers Challenge. A month later, Rosecroft-based trainer John Hollingsworth offered Ahle seven



drives on the card the night the track reopened for its winterspring meet.

"He was entering a bunch of horses and said he would put me down on all of them if I wanted to come down," Ahle said. "I did okay with those horses, and it just took off from there. So, he pretty much got me started. I'm grateful for the opportunities. I did not expect it to go this way when I first went down there. I thought it might just be a short-term thing."

On Thursday night, Ahle had drives in 12 of Rosecroft's 14 races. He got behind seven horses with morning-line odds of 9-2 or lower, including Stag Party (3-1) in the preferred handicap, Walden Woods (7-2) in the Maryland preferred open 1 and Tom's Twilight (9-2) in the Maryland preferred open 2.

"I'm definitely picking up some power, which is what you need if you're going to do well," Ahle said. "No matter who you are, as a driver you need the horsepower to be successful. It's always nice to sit behind a horse that you're confident with and know you can do well."

Ahle knew nothing about horses or racing when he started working in the stable of trainer Shaun Vallee about seven years ago. At the time, Ahle was working in a restaurant, where Vallee's daughter Sarah also worked and decided to give the equine job a try. Several months later, he left the restaurant to work fulltime with the horses.

Eventually, Ahle began driving. He started mostly in amateur races — which produced 21 of his first 25 wins — before getting his full licenses last summer. He finished last season by driving primarily at Harrah's Philadelphia and Freehold. Philly opens for its 2023 season on April 2.

"I was able to pick up good work toward the end [at Philly]," Ahle said. "It's a fun place to drive too. Hopefully, I can pick up where I left off there."

Ahle, though, has no definitive plans for the remainder of the year.

"I'll see what opportunities come my way," Ahle said. "When Rosecroft came along, I decided to take it and see where it went. I didn't know things would progress the way they did. I like driving and I'll go wherever that leads me."

In addition to driving, Ahle now works for trainer Noel Daley as well as trains one horse on his own. Last weekend, Ahle drove the Daley-trained Ignatius A-a multiple Group 1 winning pacer from Australia - to victory in the preferred handicap at Freehold.

"It was fun to win with him," Ahle said. "He's just a really cool horse to be around and nice racehorse.

"It's a blast over at Noel's. You sit behind a bunch of babies and a lot of nice racehorses. He's a cool guy to work for. You're learning something every day."

And Ahle is looking forward to every day and his continuing growth as a driver.

"Obviously, winning is fun, but all the drives mean something," Ahle said. "I'm just hopeful that everything keeps going the way it's been going."



# USTA board approves six rule and bylaw changes

Six rule and bylaw changes were approved at the annual meeting of the USTA board of directors on March 12. With the exception of the addition of a new type of lower-cost membership aimed at participants of the Standardbred Incentive Program (SIP), the changes will become effective on May 1.

These changes apply to venues in which the USTA is the sole regulatory authority. As specified in the USTA Rulebook's preface, "the rules... are applicable only to those non-parimutuel meetings over which no State Racing Commission, or other State Regulatory Body asserts primary jurisdiction." It is not uncommon, however, to see state racing commissions adopt USTA rules.

### The changes are:

- Requiring infield ponds of extended pari-mutuel tracks to be enclosed by a fence or barrier.
- Further definition of a "no contest" race.
- Streamlining of the rule governing racing, farm, corporate, stable and stallion syndicates.
- Clarification of the rule that was passed by the board on Feb. 1, in regard to artificial insemination, which will allow frozen semen to be used in the breeding seasons during and immediately following the castration or death of a stallion.
- A bylaw change to provide for a SIP non-voting membership at a lower cost for individuals competing in non-racing events with a registered Standardbred (effective Jan. 1, 2024).
- With the closing of Pompano Park, a bylaw change to redefine the election of track directors within District 6.

All of the rule changes will be sent to the Association of Racing Commissioners International and to state racing commissions with recommendations to adopt them and to horsemen's associations to assist them in promoting these rules to their state regulators to encourage their implementation.

# Gia's Surreal looks for better luck in Matchmaker

After missing the first two rounds of the 2022 Blue Chip Matchmaker Series because of a hoof issue, Gia's Surreal will be looking to put her best foot forward when this year's sixweek event for older female pacers begins Friday (March 17) at MGM Yonkers Raceway.

Gia's Surreal failed to advance to last year's Matchmaker final despite finishing third, second and first in the remaining three preliminary rounds. Needing to be in the top eight in the series standings, she was 13th and dropped into the event's \$75,000 consolation race, which she won by three-quarters of a length over Lit De Rose in 1:53.

On Friday, she starts from post three with Jason Bartlett driving for trainer Ed Hart in the third of three \$40,000 first-round Matchmaker divisions as this year's Grand Circuit season gets under way. She is the 3-1 morning-line favorite.

"She's doing really well, acts really good," Hart said. "She's a really nice mare. She fits in with everybody [in the series], for sure. Hopefully we get lucky this year."

Gia's Surreal, a daughter of So Surreal—Nancy Irene owned by James Graham, Edward Peron and Lee Winters, hit the board in 17 of 24 races last year and earned \$289,266. In addition to her two wins in the Matchmaker, her five victories in 2022 included the Forest City Pace. She was second in the Clara Barton and third in the Dayton Distaff Derby, Roses Are Red, Perfect Sting, Cleopatra Invitational and Allerage Farms Mare Pace.

For her career, the 7-year-old Gia's Surreal has won 31 of 109 races and earned \$796,893.

"She's just a tough mare," Hart said. "She's a little tough to deal with in the barn, she can get cranky once in a while, but she's just as tough on the track. She's a big hard-trying mare. She's been that way for a number of years now.

"Last year, she started out in the Matchmaker and kept racing all year long. That's tough. There are not many at this level who can do it."

### **Harness Racing Update**

Gia's Surreal made her seasonal debut in last week's open handicap for fillies and mares at Yonkers. She finished fifth as defending Matchmaker champion Drama Act nipped Racine Bell, last year's Matchmaker runner-up, by a nose. Braxton Boyd drove Gia's Surreal, with Bartlett behind Racine Bell.

Lifetime at half-mile Yonkers, Gia's Surreal has hit the board in 13 of 17 starts, with seven wins.

"She gets around any track just fine," Hart said. "She's got very good gate speed; she can make a trip. I think she's poised pretty well, actually."

In addition to Gia's Surreal, Hart will send out Lydeo in the first Matchmaker division. She will start from post six with Scott Zeron in the bike and is 20-1 on the morning line. The division features Drama Act, the 2-1 favorite and Racine Bell, the 3-1 second choice.

Last year, Lydeo won the Ruby Cook Memorial Pace final at Hollywood Casino at The Meadows and hit the board four times in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes series. She earned \$110,332 in 15 races for owners Randy Bendis, Reed Broadway and Pollack Racing.

This season, the 4-year-old mare has three second-place finishes in four starts.

"She had a good year at 3 in Pennsylvania," Hart said. "She's going to have to step it up a little bit against these tougher old mares now. Sometimes it's a tough transition, but we'll see. She's a really nice mare. She's nice to be around, nice on the track and tries hard."

Mabalene N is the 3-1 favorite in the second Matchmaker division. She will start from post two with Bartlett driving for trainer Shape Tritton

# Big M streak of \$3 million handles stands at 19

By industry standards, 2022 was a solid year at The Meadowlands as far as business goes. Average nightly handle was \$2.75 million and betting surpassed the "magic" \$3-million mark 23 times during a year that saw 85 race cards contested at the mile oval.

But 2023 — by any standard — has been a season that's seen business boom.

Last Saturday (March 11) was just another night at the salt mine for Big M management and fans, as all-source betting totaled \$3,638,285 on the 14-race card, keeping The Big M's streak of surpassing the \$3-million plateau intact.

There have been 19 Friday and Saturday night programs conducted during 2023 and everyone has seen wagering exceed \$3 million.

March has been especially marvelous, with the average nightly handle currently standing at \$3.85 million.

"There's no question, we are in a good groove," said Big M chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir. "We are extremely appreciative of our fan base. They like what our racing office has done, creating the type of competitive racing with full 10-horse fields that makes for outcomes that are harder to predict, so payoffs have a great deal of appeal to our players."

Some of the more attractive payoffs from last week include Friday's (March 10) 20-cent Pick-6 (\$9,911), 20-cent Survivor Pick-7 (\$8,323) and 20-cent Pick-5 (\$7,895).

Smiles on Saturday were worn by those who cashed in on the new "Prime Time" 10-cent Pentafecta (\$12,955) as well as the two popular 50-cent Pick-4s, that came back \$4,414 (early P4) and \$2,170 (late P4), respectively.

The Pentafecta, or, if you prefer, Hi-5, was recently added to the betting menu in the seventh race. It is in addition to the Pentafecta that has always been offered on the 14th- and final - dash of the night.

The handle projections for 2023 are big, to say the least.

The Friday and Saturday programs have seen a total of \$65,457,871 pushed through the windows, for an average nightly handle of \$3,445,151. If you include the two Sunday afternoon programs that were contested in January, that number dips to \$3,273,283, which is still far higher than the average handle per card during a superb 2021, when betting was at \$3.0 million per program.

**PICK-6 CARRYOVER:** Carryovers are something Meadowlands' fans take to like a moth to a flame and Friday (March 17), they'll be something extra in the 20-cent Pick-6 pot of gold on St. Patrick's Day.

There were no winning tickets sold on the wager last Saturday, creating a carryover of \$10,174. The last time there was a P6 carryover, \$59,027 in "new money" was put in the hat for a pool that soared to \$66,654.

It just so happens that on that March 3rd, the P6 went unhit again, which created a double carryover that attracted \$118,217 in new money the next night for a grand total of \$163,471. Those with winning tickets that evening cashed in for a handsome \$6,411, despite a sequence that saw five of the winners go off at odds of 5-1 or less.

"Our players love the opportunity to hit big," said Settlemoir. "So, whenever there are carryovers on our multi-leg wagers, there is always a lot of excitement in the building. The carryovers create great opportunities. Take this Friday, for instance. In the event there is \$66,000 or less in new money bet in the Pick-6, those with winning tickets will cash in for more money than what was bet into the pool. That's a negative takeout, which is something any player can get excited about."

**DO YOUR HOMEWORK EARLY:** Pick-6 players can get a jump on their handicapping in two big ways.

First, free past performances for every race of every Meadowlands card are available free of charge. To access the no-cost program pages, go to **playmeadowlands.com**.

Second, race reviews and selections by The Meadowlands' morning-line odds maker, program analyst and TV talent Edison Hatter are available 48 hours before a given race card. To access this valuable information from one of the brightest young minds in the sport, simply go to **playmeadowlands.com**, go to the "handicapping" tab, then click "race reviews".

**CAN 'BILL' REPEAT?** Ahundreddollarbill will be looking for a second straight victory Saturday night in the featured \$45,000 open 2/open 1 handicap for trotters.

The son of Chapter Seven—Swinging Royalty will need to bring his "A" game to overcome post 10 and will have to take down Mississippi Storm—the horse who went off as the 8-5 favorite when the pair met last week—once again. 'Storm' will depart from post two in the eighth race on the card.

Racing takes place this weekend, as usual, on Friday and Saturday night, with a first-race post time of 6:20 p.m.

# Northville Downs shares 2023 meet details

Qualifying races will again be held at Northville Downs on Thursday, March 23. First post time for qualifying races will be 11 a.m. Trainers are advised to use the USTA's Online entry system which is recommended and preferred.

Trainers are also advised to be sure they have a negative Coggins (within past 12 months) and current proof of rhino vaccination (EHV-1) within the past six months on file prior to entry with the state vet office and this will be strongly enforced for 2023. Horsemen may fax these in to 248.349.9139. In addition, horsemen should refer to the condition sheets on **ustrotting.com** for all 2023 Northville Downs' race meet guidelines and requirements.

It is important to note that the Michigan Gaming Control Board (MGCB) is instructing all horsemen and women, as well as all racing participants (including racetrack employees at all levels) to complete fingerprinting and licensing requirements before horses are entered to qualify and race. In doing so, this will allow ample time for the MGCB to receive said fingerprint results on-time prior to qualifiers and the race meet commencing.

In 2023, before you can be granted a license, you must get fingerprinted, and the results must be received by the MGCB Licensing Office. Please refer to the MGCB website for additional licensing and fingerprinting resources at www.michigan.gov/mgcb/horse-racing.

Northville Downs is excited to announce that the meet will open with purses having a nightly average of \$70,000. It is expected that horse owners and trainers will fill the box with enough entries to provide full fields and competitive races throughout the 52-night race meet.

Racing will be contested each Friday and Saturday evening, beginning April 7, through Sep. 30, with a new first race post time of 7 p.m. each race night for the Michigan oval.


