Would moving the Elitloppet from its traditional last Sunday in May spot attract more international interest?

Solvalla's sports general Anders Malmrot discusses the future of Sweden's biggest race.

Malmrot's duties at Sweden's leading racetrack include finding 16 horses prepared to race two heats in the Elitloppet in late May.

Over the years, many memorable editions of the great mile race have been held, but the trend over the years has shown that it's quite hard to attract the very best horses from all over the world. And it is exactly that — horses from different parts of the world — that Malmrot is looking for.

"Representation from many different countries is a big part of the entire event that we call the Elitloppet," Malmrot said. "The Elitloppet grows with participation from many parts of the world and the fans have their horses to follow, respectively. Basically, we see some of the best mile trotters in the world in the race, but that doesn't mean that every country that we actually want to attract has a participant."

Solvalla's sports general Anders Malmrot visits most of the important races in Europe every year. So, naturally, he booked a trip to the French Riviera when the Criterium de Vitesse was held last week at Cagnes-sur-Mer.

According to Malmrot, working on the Elitloppet is a year-long pursuit.

"You kind of live with the Elitloppet even in the fall, when Paris' meeting begins and, if we are lucky, we see some really impressive performances when you least expect it during a season," Malmrot said. "My job in finding horses for the Elitloppet intensifies when the 'B' races in Paris begin. And then comes the Prix d'Amérique, Prix de France and now, the Criterium de Vitesse."

Snow is still covering large parts of Sweden and many of the big stables haven't even shown up at the tracks yet, a fact which leads to the question: Is the Elitloppet held at the right time of the year in late May?

"That is a tricky question," Malmrot said. "The harness racing countries all over the world have their own kind of meetings at different occasions. America for example... it feels like it's tougher to attract the very best trotters from that continent nowadays and let's say that the Elitloppet would be held later on in the summer... well, then the American trainers have a lot of races to go for in USA and Canada, so it's not so easy to choose Solvalla and the Elitloppet."

But as you mention, the winter in Sweden messes it up a bit. In December, we now see green lawns and in March, the snow is falling."

In his role as director of the Elitloppet, Malmrot tries to find horses from America every year and has some in mind for this year.

"As for now, it looks like Åke [Svanstedt] or Marcus [Melander] are the trainers with horses that might be [possible] for the race," Malmrot said. "I've tried to attract Bella Bellini and Jujubee, but none of them will come this year. It doesn't look too [good] regarding American trotters. Alrajah One, trained by Åke Svanstedt is at least a horse [I'm] hoping for at this point."

Malmrot has invited Björn Goop's 6-year-old San Moteur and there are still others on his wish list.

"Obviously, Francesco Zet, but we don't know how it will be with him, if he races already in May after his stud duties," Malmrot said.

Horsy Dream was invited to the Elitloppet by Malmrot on Saturday (March 18) afternoon. Two horses are now set for the mile race at Solvalla in May: San Moteur and Horsy Dream.

"I believe that [Horsy Dream] would love a five eighths-mile track with his speed and Eric Raffin is the driver. Raffin loves to

come to Solvalla, he knows how to drive here and the horse has a cheering section that follows him wherever he starts. Horsy Dream, among several others, would be an interesting element in the Elitloppet.”

ETONNANT BACK AS A WINNER

Richard Westerink’s Elitloppet winner **Etonnant** (Timoko) made his comeback Thursday (March 16) after his sickness (Lyme disease) which hit him in Paris in January, just before the Prix d’Amérique.

Westerink found a soft task for his top trotter in Caen, France where the \$37,500 Prix de Cauvicort was contested over 1.3 miles.

Alexandre Abrivard was entrusted as the pilot behind Etonnant and he used his horse’s capacity well. The duo had to settle in position first over with three quarters of

a mile to go, but that didn’t stop Etonnant, who quite easily disarmed leader Ce Bello Romain and challenger Capital Mail in the stretch.

Etonnant’s mile rate was 1:53.4 and it seems like Westerink can aim to defend his Elitloppet title at Solvalla in May, as long as Etonnant continues to stay sound and healthy.

NEVER ENDING STORY IN CAGNES

Sunday’s (March 12) \$215,000 Criterium de Vitesse over the mile at the track in Cagnes-sur-Mer became, in a certain sense, a rerun of what we’ve witnessed at the French Riviera before. The result was a rerun, but the race itself was a more spectacular one than earlier editions as Alessandro Gocciadoro’s Yankee Glide son **Vivid Wise As** claimed the big trophy for the third time in four years.

Matthieu Abrivard took a slow start from a post far outside behind the gate and Vivid Wise As had to settle in fifth over while stable mate Vernissage Grif controlled the field in front. Franck Nivard sent the Benjamin Goetz-trained Emeraude de Bais in a three wide attack with a little less than a half mile to go.

Vivid Wise As had cover throughout the entire last turn before Abrivard had to try one last move. Vivid Wise As never looked

like the winner of the Criterium de Vitesse off the turn. Emeraude de Bais took control of the race in mid-stretch and at that point, Vivid Wise As still had plenty of lengths to make up, but a true champion never gives up. The race's last 20-30 meters became too much for Emeraude de Bais and Vivid Wise As' experience and toughness played its part, which resulted in a win by a head in 1:51.1.

Vivid Wise As set another European record by winning the Criterium de Vitesse; he's now the European trotter with the most victories in mile rates under 1:52.3, a fact that [sulkysport.se](#) presented after the race.

Emeraude de Bais was a brave runner up ahead of the Jean-Michel Bazire-trained Gently de Muze.

Vivid Wise As now has eight wins where the mile rate has been under 1:52.3 (1.10.0 in kilometer rate) and the fastest race so far was in Cagnes-sur-Mer 2019, when Gocciadoro's trotter noted a strong 1:50.2 mark over the mile.

JOVIALITY CONTINUES IN SWEDEN

Joviality (Chapter Seven—Pasithea Face) was one of the most dominant trotters in the American top races during her 2- and

3-year-old season and the Marcus Melander-trained filly was named the Dan Patch 3-Year-Old Trotting Filly of the Year for 2022.

Now, the 4-year-old mare will face another challenge as she's moving to Sweden and into the stable of trainer Sabine Kagebrandt (chief executive officer for owner Courant Stable in Sweden).

Swedish bred Joviality will most probably be aimed towards the big 4-year-old races Drottningpokalen and Stochampionatet, but when a horse with the capacity that Joviality has shown shows up in Sweden, the rumors about a possible entry in the Elitloppet start to spread. And to be fair, a horse like Joviality, with all her merits, is rarely imported to Sweden – at least as a racehorse. So, it's understood if the entourage surrounding the horse aim for the highest ranked and most prestigious races this year.

Joviality's 28 starts resulted in 20 wins, a 1:50 record mark and over \$1,600,000 in earnings.

The Blue Chip Matchmaker Series for open pacing mares picked up exactly where it left off in 2022, as defending champion **Drama Act** made a triumphant return, capturing the first of three \$40,000 divisions in the first leg of the series at Yonkers Raceway on Friday night (March 17). George Brennan guided the Ron Burke trained mare, sent off at odds of 1-5, to an imposing 1:51.3 victory.

The action was hot and heavy at the outset as second choice Racine Bell and driver Jason Bartlett blitzed the gate from post seven to secure the front on the opening bend. Wahs Fire Bug N tucked in behind her while Brennan took his time with the favored Drama Act, assuming control before the opening panel, which was posted in :27.

From there the leaders went in single file through fractions of :56.1 and 1:24.1 before Brennan called on the Well Said-sired mare and she sprinted home in-hand. Racine Bell easily held the place spot while Wahs Fire Bug N and Alta Madeira N finished third and fourth, respectively.

Owned by The OK Corral, Drama Act, who now has 33 career victories and earnings of \$858,972, was a winner for the fourth

time in five 2023 starts and returned \$2.60 to win. The chalk exacta paid \$6.20, with the triple a solid \$33.

Amazing Dream N showed the way for Yannick Gingras in the second \$40,000 division as the 4-5 favorite. The Bettor's Delight-sired import set fractions of :27.2 and :57.1 for the opening half as pocket-sitter Easy To Please and Jordan Stratton stalked her in second while the second-choice, Lit De Rose, sat third. Amazing Dream N accelerated off the easy half, hitting three-quarters in 1:25 as Lit De Rose edged off the pylons to challenge.

Gingras let the Linda Toscano-trained mare pace in the homestretch and she kicked home in :27.3, completing the mile in 1:52.3 in her 2023 and Yonkers debut. Easy To Please held off Lit De Rose for the place spot, with Annerie N finishing fourth.

Owned by Enviro Stable, Richard Gutnick, Tom Pontone and Joseph Lozito Jr., Amazing Dream N returned \$3.90, 3.00 and \$2.20 across the board. The exacta returned \$14.60 and the trifecta came back at \$36.60. Amazing Dream N made her 27th appearance in the winner's circle and she has now pocketed \$1,270,486.

The third division of the Blue Chip Matchmaker saw heated competition from start to finish and the 7-1 **Karma Seelster** and Matt Kakaley rallied off a third-over trip to post the upset following a thrilling stretch drive.

Sweet Treasure and driver Andrew McCarthy blasted out from post eight and secured the front late on the opening turn, looping the favorite Gia's Surreal and Jason Bartlett and forcing another leaver, Lucky Artist A and Braxten Boyd, to tuck in fourth.

Bartlett would eventually seize control, but Gia's Surreal would need a :26.4 first quarter to do so. Bartlett slowed the pace slightly, but the half was still a solid :55.3 when Delitfulcatherin N and Jordan Stratton began their offensive, followed by Lucky Artist A and Karma Seelster in the outer tier.

A spirited third quarter saw the top two on even-terms through three quarters in 1:23.4 and heading into the final turn Kakaley surprised Boyd, sending Karma Seelster three-wide early and briefly blindswitching their rival. That move gave Karma Seelster the momentum and she carried it to the finish line while Boyd found clearance early enough to make a race of it to the wire. In the end Karma Seelster prevailed in 1:52.4, winning for the third time in seven starts this year for trainer Andrew Adamczyk. Lucky Artist A finished second, with Delitfulcatherin N holding third gamely after the overland journey. Gotthegreenlight was a solid fourth after clearing late in the mile.

Karma Seelster is owned by Karen Hauver and Shady Hill Racing Stable. The 6-year-old daughter of Sportswriter returned \$16.60 to win. The exacta was \$70.50 and there was a \$185.50 trifecta. Karma Seelster has a lifetime record of 18-15-14 from 70 tries, and she pushed her bankroll to \$752,948.

Preliminary round action in the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series will continue through Friday, April 14 and will conclude with a \$125,000 added final that should go for at least \$250,000 on April 24. The final of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series and companion consolation races for both events will also occur that night.

The 2023 edition of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series for free-for-alls will begin on Monday night (March 20) at MGM Yonkers Raceway with four \$50,000 divisions on the 12-race program.

MGM Yonkers Raceway is currently operating on a Monday through Friday live racing schedule with post time at 7 p.m. (EST).

Readers are reminded that because a person's name appears on the list does not necessarily mean they are guilty of an offense. Many times, cases are not finalized and many of the accused are still entitled to due process.

Also, please note, for context, the first link is to the Association of Racing Commissioners International's classification system of drug penalties to give readers a sense of the difference between a Class 1 and a Class 4 positive.

TALES FROM THE CURMUDGEON

Stories about Frank Safford and a conversation with Dave McDuffee

Periodically, I hope to speak of some of the characters in our sport with whom I have had contact. They will range from the silly to the serious. One of the biggest, both in terms of size and overwhelming personality, was Frank Safford.

If you had ever met Safford, you doubtless would have never forgotten the experience. He could have been the poster boy for a bigger-than-life personality.

He was a big, gruff man with a loud raspy voice which matched his stature.

I will cite three stories about him, all of which I heard second hand.

The first was told to me by Lawrence B. Sheppard the owner of Hanover Shoe Farms. Safford was known as a far-from-lily-white personage who was not adverse to wagering on horses, perhaps sometimes in skirting the rules.

In his later years, Safford would hold court with a bunch of his cronies outside the paddock at Liberty Bell Park.

It seems that Safford was in trouble with Liberty Bell Park's presiding judge Milt Taylor. Sheppard knew for a fact that Safford was, in this instance, not guilty of the offense for which he was being charged. Sheppard was then the head of the Pennsylvania Harness Racing Commission. The offense came up before him and although Sheppard knew that Safford was not exactly a choir boy, he felt certain that he was not guilty of this particular offense. He took his friend, judge Taylor aside and told him, "Milt, I believe in this case you're in the right church, but you've got the wrong pew." Safford was exonerated of the charges.

John Simpson told me the next Safford tale. One of Safford’s owners was a North Carolinian named Lee Herrin. Safford had three of Herrin’s horses in at Roosevelt Raceway one night. He won with all three.

After the races Safford went to one of the horsemen’s hangouts, the Maple House, for dinner and some adult beverages. Who should come in but Herrin. Herrin was bouncing off the walls with happiness. “Frank,” Herrin said rather loudly. “You’re the best. You won with all three of mine, I’m going to buy you the biggest steak dinner they can find in this place.”

By then Safford was well into his cups.

“Lee, I’ll tell you what,” Safford said. “You can buy me that steak dinner when I lose three with three of yours.”

The third tale was told to me by Norman Woolworth. As most of you probably know, Woolworth was an heir to the F.W. Woolworth stores. In the early years of Woolworth’s, the stores were sometimes called five-and-dime stores.

Woolworth loved all sports, particularly harness racing. At the time, he would sometimes drive his own horses, but not particularly well as he would say. He was in a race in Maine with Safford. Woolworth was riding the rail and Safford was approaching from the outside. Woolworth was thinking of pulling the right line. Safford sensed that. Woolworth heard this booming rasping voice hollering, “Five and dime, you just stay where you are and nobody will get hurt.” Woolworth stayed where he was and nobody was hurt.

McDuffee is the furthest thing from being a person inclined to pop off or act without thinking. There is not much that will cause him to get his ire up.

One of the few things that will is the fact that Brett Pelling is not yet a member of Harness Racing’s Living Hall of Fame.

“I’m not about to be critical of those already enshrined in Goshen,” McDuffee said. “They are all more than deserving of the honor. But Brett Pelling has accomplished more than most. Listing all of his achievements and top horses would probably require a book. I hope I am not being too critical of the Hall of Fame. Heck, I am one of its directors and I am proud to serve in that position. Nevertheless, lacking another description of why Brett is not installed requires only one word. That word is disgraceful. It is not only disgraceful that he is not one of its members, but it reflects poorly on the Hall itself and more specifically on those who choose the candidates.

“I’m not about to even remotely suggest that those who choose the candidates are guilty of prejudice, but I find it rather strange that we have several Swedes, all of whom are deserving, but not a single person from Down Under in Goshen. It’s certainly not because they haven’t had an influence on North American racing. I ask myself ‘Why?’ Just look at the accomplishments of several who have more than distinguished themselves in our sport. Enough belaboring the negatives though. It’s beyond time to correct a major injustice and to install Brett Pelling among the greats of our sport.”

Keystone Kops and karma

With a little luck on your side, procrastination can pay off.

Owning a broodmare is my favorite part of harness racing. Each foal that enters the world is a story. Following each story is fascinating. My pal and I are bit players, but each day, for each horse, from choosing a sire until the hammer falls at an auction, is an intriguing adventure. Like any adventure, there are good times and not-so-good times.

We try to plan carefully in our breeding exploits, but you know the adage about the best-laid plans of mice and men. A dozen of our carefully planned yearling sales went astray. On the other hand, our best-selling yearling and best racehorses were flukes. For us, every step in raising a yearling is somewhere between the Keystone Kops and karma.

Our current story is reaching a critical point: a foal's birth. So far, before this creature has breathed fresh air, karma has played a significant role in this story. Once again, these are real harness horses with actual events, but names are not listed to protect the innocent.

About a year ago, in April 2022, our mare gave birth to her second baby, a filly that joined our non-paying band. So here we stood, a broodmare, a yearling romping in the field and another baby nursing. The birth always signals the need to dive in deeper and breed our mare to another stallion, escalating the madness.

At that time, everything in our little breeding world was unknown except for monthly bills, stud fees, registration fees, X-rays and the occasional vet bill. Still, no money was incoming, while the outgoing

money remained steady. And more money would be flying out the door with sales prep, videos, staking, cataloging and various bills for the fall sale.

The math gets fuzzy, but because we overlapped with another broodmare, we were up to five horses of various ages lounging around the farm. We had delusions of adequacy and good fortune, but nothing is assured. Here is a tip for anyone considering getting into the breeding game: events can snowball and get out of hand amazingly quickly. You visit the farm, look around and wonder what happened. You suddenly have a herd of horses and years without a dollar of income from a sale in sight.

At this point in our tale from last year, deciding on the next stallion for our broodmare, I must assume responsibility for the events. I am a card-carrying member of the Oscar Wilde school of procrastination. Wilde once said, "I never put off till tomorrow what I can do the day after."

I wait until just before the mare foals to sign up for a stallion for the same reason I rarely RSVP to parties: you never know what might arise. My postponement of responsibility irritates my horse partner, but for me, early planning takes away spontaneity.

We had not booked a trotting stallion for the breeding of our broodmare. We had discussed several potential stallions at length, but the ink had yet to meet the contract. Some stallions fill their book. Our top two candidates were among those listed: Book full and closed. I call this karma. My pal calls my procrastination stupid.

Never fear. There was an intriguing new stallion with a whiff of "Swedishness" at a secluded farm in our state. I had never heard this stallion's name, nor was I familiar with his racetrack achievements until I stumbled across a notification in this publication. I emailed for a booking, but nothing happened. What happened for those few days is a bit of a mystery, perhaps a communication error on my part. However, after a few unsuccessful attempts at contacting my Swedish sleeper stallion, the clock was ticking and we still did not have a stallion lined up. We were now down to our fourth stallion candidate, a stallion that stood just down the road.

The down-the-road stallion was always one of our fallback positions. This neighboring stallion had not received many mares during years one and two, so we would not be shut out. Plus, the guy who ran the farm was a friend. We booked this sire and our broodmare became pregnant with baby number three. Honestly, this third breeding was a bit of a letdown. Broodmare owners were not knocking down the door for this stallion during his first two seasons and although he looked outstanding to us, we figured this stallion would have limited commercial value. He had the earmarks of producing a homebred for racing.

But here is where karma paid a visit.

For some reason, or reasons, that we still do not comprehend, when the first crop of this stallion went to market in the fall, his small crop sold crazy well. Buyers kept bidding, he had the sales topper and his average yearling price led the sale. His popularity amazed us. His small second small crop goes to market this fall. His third small crop, which we will belong to, sells the following year. His fourth crop will be significant: he raised his fee and filled his book before Thanksgiving. How often does a stallion have his booking explode in his fourth season?

The story of our next foal, scheduled to emerge from the womb in a few weeks, is just beginning. Due to the sire leaping onto centerstage from nowheresville, this foal could be in an

excellent position if all goes well. But, of course, many things can happen between those first teetering steps in the straw and the banging hammer at an auction.

After the foaling, our insanity continues as we face the annual game of stallion selection. Currently, we have at least ten options with different prices and state eligibilities.

Breaking news: I mentioned how and why I procrastinate a few paragraphs ago. Guess what? Another possible sire announced today, a late entry onto our menu of 2023 trotting stallions. Although I never heard of him until this morning, he goes on our list.

The next few weeks will be a lot of fun. We will make our lists, plead our cases and study glossy stallion advertisements searching for our next stallion choice. Looking years down the road and predicting what will strike the fancy of yearling customers is an exciting challenge. Our selection process will be a blast, but I can't help thinking that putting a dozen stallion names in a hat, reaching into that hat and letting karma take over might be the best way for the Keystone Kops to roll.

Crazy Fool takes TrackMaster final at Big M

The TrackMaster Series for horses with a figure of 74.25 or less is an event designed to give horses of modest talent a chance to race for some bigger purses than they might ordinarily compete for.

But the winner of Friday night's (March 17) \$15,000 series final for trotters at The Meadowlands looks like a horse who could prove to be far better than modest.

Crazy Fool, whose explosive final quarter a week ago led to a shocking 40-1 score in the series' second and final leg, came right back to win again, but this time, the 3-year-old gelded son of Crazy Wow—Winkys Gal had the confidence of the betting public and despite not getting the best of trips, prevailed with ease to stay unbeaten in two starts this year.

Sent to the gate as the 8-5 favorite, driver Marcus Miller was in no hurry — over a surface that saw no horse on the 14-race card win in wire-to-wire fashion — and sat eighth past the half in a third-over flow, racing well back off a contested :57.4 pace.

But Miller remained confident in Crazy Fool.

"[Trainer] Claude [Huckabone III] had him super ready," Miller said. "He's still green but they mixed it up just enough."

Crazy Fool was tipped off his cover at three-quarters, raced three-wide around the final half of the far turn and then sprinted home to collar leader Bet Big On Blue nearing the wire. The pocket-sitting Golden Cross Stone gunned down Bet Big On Blue for the place spot.



Crazy Fool won it by a half-length while completing the mile in 1:56.1 and paid \$5.20 to win.

"I imagine he's heading into the [New York] Sire Stakes," said Miller. "They'll probably bump him up [from the Excelsior, where he raced as a 2-year-old, to the high-level competition]. He seems like the type of horse who can do it. I wanted to be in range. He's still figuring out what he has to do but he was charging. He's a nice horse."

Crazy Fool is now four-for-10 lifetime — with five second-place finishes — for owners Anne Morgan, Richard Dieck and C.L. Huckabone Jr.

20 IN A ROW: All-source betting totaled \$3,250,074, keeping The Big M's streak of surpassing the magic \$3-million mark intact.

There have been 20 Friday and Saturday night programs conducted during 2023 and every one has seen wagering exceed \$3 million.

During 2022, betting went past the \$3-million mark 23 times during the 85-program season.

A LITTLE MORE: Dave Miller, aka "Purple Jesus," aka "The Buckeye," led the driver colony with three victories on the night. Nifty Norman and Edwin Quevedo led the trainers with a pair of winners each. A carryover of \$10,174 led to over \$50,000 in "new money" pumped into the 20-cent Pick-6 pot for a grand total of \$61,424. After a sequence that saw winner's odds of 8-5, 9-2, 8-1, 7-2, 1-5 and 7-2, those with all six correct collected \$1,584.14.

Rideau Carleton Raceway season set to start April 2

Despite fears the call to post would not sound this year, the 2023 racing season will go on after all at the Rideau Carleton Raceway (RCR) starting Sunday, April 2, 2023. The season, which was originally set to kick off on March 19, was delayed after a two-alarm fire destroyed the Raceway's staging barn on Feb. 15.

Thanks to the immediate actions by first responders, no animals, people, or other facilities were harmed in the fire.

"Watching those flames engulf the barn on that fateful night, I honestly feared the racing season may have been lost," said Rideau Carleton Raceway racing manager Peter Andrussek. "We have the horse racing community to thank for this quick turnaround."

Over the past six weeks, RCR employees, horse people and contractors have banded together to retrofit an unused stable barn to be able to paddock horses and their teams on race days. With this temporary installation in place and with the support of the racing community and regulatory bodies, the season can go on.

"The racing team's unwavering commitment and dedication to salvaging the season has been nothing short of extraordinary," said Helen MacMillan, general manager, Rideau Carleton Casino. "I want to thank them for their creativity and hard work during this challenging time."

Because of the two-week delay, the original schedule has been amended to remove all previously scheduled March dates and to add Wednesday night cards through the month of April.

Throughout April, live harness racing will take place on Wednesdays (post time 7 p.m.) and Sundays (post time 6:30 p.m.). The RCR will switch to its original weekly schedule of racing Thursdays (post time 4 p.m.) and Sundays (post time 6:30 p.m.) in May and for the rest of the season.

The revised 2023 racing schedule, which has been approved by Ontario Racing, the **Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario** and the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency, is available at www.rideaucarletoncasino.com/racetrack.asp.

The Rideau Carleton Raceway officially opened on Sep. 1, 1962, as Canada's first ever five-eighths mile oval. It has been a key part of Ontario's harness racing community ever since. Last September, the raceway celebrated its 60th anniversary with a fireworks' display and a special invitation-only event inside the casino with over 200 guests gathering to share stories and pay tribute to those who contributed to the success of the raceway over the years.

Recipe for improving harness racing

The other night a few friends and I were talking about how to improve a few things about harness racing. The strangest thing is, yes I have a few friends.

This is what we came up with:

- Trainers can't have two horses in the same race even if they have different owners.
- Post time is post time.
- No betting on elimination races where you need to finish fifth or better.
- The starting gate should be more angled to give outside horses a better chance especially on half-mile tracks, or should start 50 yds earlier to make it a longer run to the first turn. A run up, like the thoroughbreds. Timer doesn't start till the mile line.
- If you're sitting third on the rail and you don't pull, \$50 fine. You're not trying to win, you screwed the public.
- Allowing a nice tuck going to the quarter. Nice for your buddy, not nice to the public.
