# Canadian calamity: What a horrible few weeks it has been

*Another soul-kicking shutdown of racing in Ontario comes on the heels of the death of three Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame members, plus the death of Garry Pye, one of Somebeachsomewhere's key owners.*

Canada's harness racing industry has been hit hard in the last couple of weeks with another shutdown of racing in Ontario due to the pandemic and the death of three standardbred members of the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame – builder Bob Burgess, game-changing stallion Kadabra and stellar race mare Tricky Tooshie – as well as Tuesday's (April 6) death of Garry Pye, one of the key owners of the late, great Hall of Fame pacer Somebeachsomewhere.

On Thursday (April 8), with variant strains of COVID-19 on the rise, ICUs filling up and vaccines lagging far behind the U.S., the Ontario government followed up last week's province-wide "shutdown" by issuing a more stringent stay-at-home order that forced even training at racetracks to halt ([see story pg. 4](#)) and deals a serious blow to hopes that racing – which has operated safely throughout the pandemic – could return before the latest health restrictions are set to expire in a month's time, at the earliest ([full story here](#)).

Horses are already leaving the province to race in the U.S. and there are concerns about horse population in the province once racing does resume. Meanwhile, Woodbine's thoroughbred operation has had to delay its opening day originally scheduled for April 17.

During all this uncertainty, Burgess (who is profiled further on [pg 5](#)), died Saturday at age 85, a week after Kadabra was laid to rest at Tara Hills Stud in Port Perry, ON where he stood at stud for his entire career. Hanover Shoe Farms

announced earlier this week that Quebec star Tricky Tooshie had died at age 31. The first Canadian-bred millionaire mare had been a beloved member of the famed farm's retired broodmare band since she had her last foal in 2015 ([see story pg. 9](#)).

News of Pye's death came as we were finishing this issue. Look for more information on his passing in Sunday's issue of HRU.

Burgess was instrumental in starting the Ontario Sires Stakes program – which this year is scheduled to offer purses of more than \$14 million (Cdn) – and in bringing Hall of Fame stallion Balanced Image to stand in Ontario during the program's infancy. Balanced Image and the OSS program were both game changers for the Ontario breed and played a huge role for setting the condition for Kadabra to come to Ontario to stand stud.

In January, Tara Hills owner David Heffering announced Kadabra had been retired from stud duty due to a serious suspensory injury ([full story here](#)). The injury ended the 22-year-old trotter's 17-year stallion career with progeny credits exceeding \$100 million by Standardbred Canada accounting (Kadabra sits at \$91.6 million, eighth all-time among trotters, by USTA records) and one Hambletonian winner (Forbidden Trade, 2019) to his credit.

At the time of Kadabra's retirement, Heffering said he had already marked out a spot for the stallion's final resting place – a beautiful spot at the top of a hill overlooking the Port Perry, ON farm.

Kadabra himself was a winner of more than \$1.8 million on the track. The Illinois-bred son of Primrose Lane out of Quillo was bred by Connie Hochstetler and campaigned by

her husband, Homer, until being sold to a group led by Heffering's late father, Peter — the founder of Tara Hills Stud — in the early days of the trotter's 3-year-old season.

The trotter meant a tremendous amount to the Hochstetler family and on March 29 Connie and Homer's son, Jay Hochstetler, posted the following tribute to Kadabra on his Facebook page (which we republish here with his permission):

*A little piece of me is gone. I'll do my best to put into words what this horse meant to me but just know it will not do it justice.*

*He's the horse from a best-selling fiction novel. My grandparents gave us his sire. Our family friend gave us his dam. I named him after my favorite Pokémon. Lo and behold this off bred Illinois trotter becomes a World Champion from humble roots.*

*He built my childhood home. He gave me financial security and put us on the map as a force in Illinois. He played a huge role in giving me the best childhood I could ask for.*

*I had been planning to go visit him the last few years and had it all mapped out for last year until COVID came. I'll always live with the regret that I never got to see him after his racing career.*

*Thanks for everything you did for me buddy. You deserve the eternal bliss that I know you've passed on to.*

It is a beautiful tribute, to be sure, during a very tough couple of weeks in the Great White North.

## Government's stay-at-home order suspends training at Woodbine Mohawk Park

As a result of the **Provincial State of Emergency declared Wednesday (April 7) by the Government of Ontario**, which includes a province-wide 28-day stay-at-home order effective Thursday, April 8 at 12:01 a.m., Woodbine Entertainment announced that training at Woodbine Mohawk Park will be suspended immediately. Training will be offered again after the stay-at-home order is lifted or when there is clarity on when live racing will be permitted to resume.

Woodbine Entertainment also confirmed that it is continuing its efforts with government officials and local health authorities to be permitted to safely operate live racing during a lockdown situation which would allow the standardbred racing season at Woodbine Mohawk Park to resume after the stay-at-home order is lifted on May 6.

"This is very difficult news to share with our Woodbine Mohawk Park community," said Jim Lawson, CEO, Woodbine Entertainment. "Since the beginning of the pandemic in Ontario more than a year ago, we have supported the Government of Ontario every step of the way and will continue to do so.

"However, if we do not receive permission to safely operate live racing during a lockdown situation after the stay-at-home is lifted, our industry and business could be greatly impacted as more and more trainers will be sending their horses to the United States where there are plenty of racing opportunities. This situation has the potential to have a devastating and long-lasting impact on the standardbred industry in Ontario."

Woodbine Entertainment will continue to provide regular updates to keep horse people informed of the latest developments regarding training and live racing at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Woodbine has also announced that the 2021 thoroughbred meet at Woodbine Racetrack has been postponed.

The season was scheduled to begin on Saturday, April 17.

"This is very difficult news to share with our horsepeople, horse players and fans throughout North America and the world," said Lawson.

During stay-at-home order, Woodbine will continue to operate the backstretch at Woodbine Racetrack as an essential service for the stabling, training and care of horses. Active training, including timed workouts, will continue but starting gate and receiving barn training operations will be temporarily suspended for 10 days.

## Remembering the “greatest highs and lows” of Bob Burgess

My favorite memory of Bob Burgess came after Amigo Hall won the Hambletonian in 2003. You need to understand the context.

Burgess, a 2011 inductee to the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame who died Saturday (April 3) at the age of 85, owned the trotter with his daughter-in-law Karin and the colt's breeder, Walnut Hall. The fact Amigo Hall is a son of Balanced Image that was trained by Bob's son and Karin's husband, Blair Burgess, was even better.

Bob, a proud Canadian who was instrumental in founding the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) program with people such as Lloyd Chisholm, Dr. Glen Brown and others, was also the man most responsible for bringing Balanced Image to stand in Ontario, thus changing the Canadian breed.

Amigo Hall was just the second Canadian-sired horse to win the Hambletonian, coming only three years after Yankee Paco, another son of Balanced Image, first did it for trainer

Amigo Hall was also the first horse Blair raced in the Hambletonian. After the colt won, I went hunting through the old Meadowlands grandstand to find Bob in one of the track's many dining rooms to congratulate him and get some comments for my story. The first thing he said when I shook his hand was, "The horse should never have been 27-1... The odds were the craziest odds I've ever seen. I thought he'd be 8-1 or 10-1."

That was quintessential Bob Burgess, a man with a unique world view to match his considerable passion for harness racing.

I was laughing about just that memory with Blair the other night while picking his brain to try to craft a proper remembrance of his father, who was laid to rest Thursday (April 8) after a small service.

"It was about getting enough respect," Blair said of his father's first reaction to winning the sport's greatest trotting prize. "That's a Canadian inferiority complex... and that might be a horse owner's disease. A lot of horse owners are like that."

Bob Burgess did just about everything in the industry except drive horses, but he mostly maintained the

perspective of a horse owner that Blair said was both a blessing and a curse.

"You likely can't get too Shakespearean, but in some ways, some people would consider him a tragic character. So much opportunity and skill, but the ego of horse ownership and its intoxicating aspects cost him dearly at times," said Blair, who asked for an honest appraisal of his father.

“Everybody is great after they die,” Blair said. “He certainly had his enemies, certainly pissed some people off along the way and he experienced... the greatest highs and the greatest lows.”

The highs for Robert 'Bob' Burgess, Queen's Counsel (an honorary title of used to recognize Canadian lawyers for exceptional merit and contribution to the legal profession), were the aforementioned Balanced Image, OSS program, Amigo Hall and berths in the Canadian Hall of Fame for both himself and Blair, who is also in the Living Hall of Fame in the U.S.

Bob also owned parts of such stars as Amity Chef, Frugal Gourmet, Road Machine, Real Desire, Tell All, Blue Porsche, Armbro Deuce and Glidemaster, a second Hambletonian winner for him and Blair and Karin.

“Winning the Hambletonian with (Amigo Hall), a Canadian bred that was a son of Balanced Image, I think was especially sweet,” Blair said. “(And) he was always proud of the Sires Stakes program.”

Balanced Image, a 2000 inductee to the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame, produced more winners than any trotting stallion in history, including those two Hambletonian champions. His progeny earned more than \$105 million.

Bob's lows in the game included the provincial government pulling the plug on the Slots at Racetracks Program (SARP) in 2012, the financial problems that caused him to lose his Cantario stallion farm where Balanced Image first stood in Ontario and a long involvement with the standardbred breeders' lawsuit against the province seeking damages for ending SARP. That suit has dragged on for eight years and is still not fully resolved. Blair said his father was the sixth or seventh plaintiff to have died since the lawsuit was first filed.

“There's been several times when he's had to put on the dog and pony show to try and regroup and come back again,” Blair said of his father. “He did live on the edge. In the end, maybe it even hastened his demise, because he was definitely overwrought on the breeders' lawsuit, way overwrought on that.”

Fittingly, some of Bob's final moments came watching horses.

“He watched horses train at my place on Friday. He watched horses train at Anthony (MacDonald's) on Saturday,” Blair said. “He took his car to the shop on Saturday afternoon to get a tire fixed and then died Saturday night around supper, after he went for a short walk... He probably didn't recognize some signs... If he checked himself into a hospital on Friday afternoon or Saturday morning, he'd probably still

be with us. He probably had a massive embolism or something, because he had these mobility issues the last five or six years.”

A thorough — and, according to Blair — accurate accounting of Bob's involvement in the business was compiled by [Standardbred Canada this week and can be read here](#).

Further to that, Blair told me his father bred horses, occasionally foaled them and long held a trainer's license.

“He never let it go, he always was an 'owner/trainer' on his license. He kept it up his whole life, as far as I know. I don't think he ever had a start as a trainer, but he did have a trainer's license,” Blair said.

“When I was a kid, we'd foal mares together, too. He foaled mares himself on the farm. Other than drive a horse, I think he did just about everything in the horse business.

“He helped me a lot. When I set out on my own in the mid-'90s, he rode shotgun or drove me all over to all these tracks all over America, racing horses for Brittany Farms and really not for him. He wanted to make sure that things went in the right direction for me, and he certainly helped me there.”

Blair said he and his father also had a complicated relationship that went beyond the typical challenges of fathers and sons to also

encompass a boss-employee dynamic.

"He would be livid if I wasn't current on a topic to the level he expected, and I think later in life I purposely aggravated him with ignorance. He also knew how to make one feel guilty: for staying up too late, coming to work too late, having what he considered frivolous endeavors or concerns. But he was certainly my 'go to' on pedigree of the horses. He'd call me on conformation, but I still trusted him to look at horses for me as sort of an advance man. I said he was active in all parts of game and up to a few years ago he would often volunteer to even ship horses for me, and I would take him up on it if second trainers or I were too busy."

Bob also had a large family. He and his first wife, the late Vera Burgess, had five children and the clan now counts 17 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. Bob leaves behind his second wife, Heather, whom Blair calls "a life saver" for his father over the last decade.

As a lawyer, Bob was proud of his Q.C. title and for the countless equine cases he argued, many on behalf of those in the industry that couldn't navigate bureaucracy themselves.

"He was director of Contrans trucking company for a long time. He was one of the original shareholders there," Blair said. "He also did the legal work for (Canadian rock band) The Stampeders way back when he was a young lawyer... They weren't BTO, but they were hot for a while. He went to the Junos with them. He did some cool stuff when he was a young lawyer. He was a young, city lawyer for 30 years before this horse stuff. In hindsight, I almost wish he'd kept on that trajectory and maybe done the horses more on the side, because in some ways the horses wore him out," Blair said.

"He was hardcore, avid reader, not of novels, but he'd be reading autobiographies and historical stuff. He was a polymath on that kind of material. For a while, because of all that stuff, he traded his own account on the market... It was another fortune won and lost, but he did extremely well for a while in the early 2000s just trading his own account at home... In the summertime, he would golf four or five times a week... and cherished his ClubLink membership.

"There was more to him than horses."

Indeed, but horses were rarely far away.

On that score, Bob Burgess had more than his share of both glory and failures, but there's no denying there was a richness to both his life and his contribution.

## Canadian Hall of Fame mare Tricky Tooshie dead at 31

It is with great sadness that Hanover Shoe Farms announces that millionaire pacing mare and 2019 Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame inductee Tricky Tooshie p,1:52.1 (\$1,005,556) has died at the age of 31. Tricky Tooshie had her last foal, Techino Hanover, in 2015 and has been a beloved member of Hanover's retired mare band since.

Born April 22, 1990 in Mercier, QC, Tricky Tooshie was a dominant performer in Quebec Sire Stakes Action as a 2 and 3-year-old for owner Laurent Bergevin and trainer Jean-Louis Deblois. As a 4-year-old she was shipped to Ontario and for the next 5 seasons regularly competed against and defeated the best distaffers in that province. Described by trainer Rick Zeron as "thriving on winning" Tricky Tooshie certainly left that in her foals and particularly in a well-known granddaughter named Lyons Sentinel. Bred by Hanover, Lyon Sentinel p,3,1:49.2 (\$1,236,361) is a daughter of Captaintreacherous out of Tricky Tooshie's daughter Tutu Hanover and was the 2019 Dan Patch 2-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year (the same year her illustrious grandmother was inducted into the Hall of Fame).

"Tooshie was genuinely a favorite of mine," said Hanover's executive vice-president Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky. "She had her quirks but she was tough and all business. She has passed that on to her foals and her grand-foals. Coincidentally, we just purchased her granddaughter, Trillions Hanover p,1:49.3 (\$344,741), the Somebeachsomewhere sister to Lyons Sentinel and hope she will continue Tooshie's legacy."

Hanover would like to send their condolences to Tricky Tooshie's caretaker and final trainer Linda Bedard who visited Tooshie in Hanover during her retirement and clearly loved her.

## Shades Demsky is making his mark

Andrew "Shades" Demsky may be the new kid on the block, but that's okay, since he's got the right stuff.

Demsky, 33, is the first to admit that his harness racing background is limited, but what he lacks in experience, he makes up for in dedication.

"What I always appreciated about Shades was his passion," said director of racing for Caesar's Entertainment Gabe Prewitt, who worked a Red Mile meeting with Demsky in 2014. "He does his homework. He does a lot of research and I know how much he applies himself when he's working."

It was Prewitt who introduced Demsky to Meadowlands chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir at the Harrisburg Sale in 2019. Settlemoir was apparently familiar with Demsky's work at the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Association (PHRA) and at Tampa Bay Downs, when he was doing on-air TV handicapping.

Demsky had left the job at the PHRA at the end of 2019 and once the pandemic hit his options were limited until he received a call from Settlemoir.

"Jason calls me out of the blue and offers me a job at Tioga, and how do you say no?" said Demsky. "That's exciting."

Demsky was hired as the assistant race secretary and

announcer at Tioga Downs, and even though he was not an expert at either job, he was willing to put in the work to become one.

"The more you learn, the better, so I'm never going to say no to learning something new," he said. "It took me a long time to find out what flushes out cover means. Flat out, the Internet does not have that. You cannot find, 'So and so flushes out cover.' Some terms just don't exist on the Internet. There are just things you have to ask people when push comes to shove."

Hall of Famer Wally Hennessey got to know Demsky during his time at Tioga last year and was impressed with how quickly he caught on to our sport.

"So, that tells me that's somebody who's willing to listen and learn," said Hennessey. "He wasn't just there for a paycheck. This was something he wanted to pursue in life and he's actually gaining traction way faster than most people would."

"That's what we need in the sport. Young blood that has a deep interest in what we're doing. He wants to know all aspects of the game and that can only bode well for us in the future. We're going to be a better sport because of him."

Demsky, who grew up on Long Island near Belmont Park, graduated from Hofstra University in just three years with a 3.92 GPA and a degree in Radio, TV and Film production.

He put that degree to good use for four years working production jobs for three different minor league baseball teams, but it was horse racing – not baseball – that Demsky aspired to be part of.

"My grandfather was a big horse player," said Demsky. "He was married to Roosevelt until Roosevelt closed and they wound up moving to New Jersey and Freehold was his spot





until Off-Track Wagering became a thing. He never got to see me work in harness racing, which I think he would have loved, because that was his thing.”

In 2013, Demsky took a job at Tampa Bay Downs in their production room, but he still longed to watch the races live.

Later that year, Demsky saw that Presque Isle Downs in Erie, PA, was looking for a simulcast host.

He went to Margo Flynn, Tampa’s vice president of marketing and on-air handicapper, to see if she would put in a good word for him.

“And her response was, ‘I like you, but can you even do that?’” said Demsky. “So, I said, ‘Sure.’ She said ‘Okay, tomorrow you’re doing the last race on camera.’

“So, I had to borrow a dress shirt to go on air and I did my little spiel and she said ‘You did okay. Do it again.’”

So, for the last month of that season, Demsky was the pre-race analyst for the last race every day.

“We got to the end of the season and she said, ‘Next year, would you like to come back and take over for me?’” said Demsky, who worked at Tampa a total of six seasons.

It was during his stint at Tampa that Demsky received his moniker.

While doing his pre-race analysis, he kept looking down to check his notes and the girl running camera said, ‘Why don’t you just put your sunglasses on?’

But then somebody on social media belittled him, referring to him on Twitter as “that Shades kid” and “that Shades guy”.

“So, I basically took that negative and went to my boss and said I designed a shades logo for myself, that I still use today, and I said, ‘Can I run with this?’” said Demsky. “And she said, ‘Sure try it.’ And it kind of stuck, and I like it.”

Anyone who follows The Big M on social media are well aware of what Demsky has done since becoming the racing and simulcast manager at The Meadowlands when Tioga’s meet ended last year.

In addition to being an on-air analyst on “Racing from The Meadowlands”, Demsky has capitalized on his marketing background to come up with “Holiday Games”, “Meadowlands Mean Tweets” and “Big M Game Night.”

Demsky’s first of three Holiday Games segments happened on his first night doing paddock interviews right before Thanksgiving. And even though some drivers may have run from him, others at least, gave him a chance.

“Where they might have been, ‘What is this crazy guy in sunglasses doing?’ initially, [now] they kind of see I’m not that bad,” said Demsky. “I think they see I’m not going to make them look bad in the final product.”

A new edition of Meadowlands Mean Tweets came out April 1 and got a great reception as one of the most viewed videos they’ve had between their YouTube and Facebook view accounts.

“I think he has a fresh perspective on that stuff,” said Tioga stakes administrator Nick Salvi. “The mean tweets is not something that appeals to me personally, but I’m not the target, and people do seem to like it. It is a transition from thoroughbred to standardbred and truth be known, he’s made great strides in a short time doing something that you can’t really teach somebody to do.

“He’s willing to do whatever you ask, and he applies himself. He has imagination and maybe a different perspective than what we’re used to, us standardbred regulars.”

Demsky’s latest creation, Big M Game Night, premiered on Monday, April 5 and new episodes will debut on April 12 and 19 on Instagram, Twitter YouTube and Facebook at 5 p.m.

“I know Hollywood Game Night was a huge show for like five years,” said Demsky. “So [I thought] maybe I could have these guys play games that everybody knows. And it was hard to convince them to do this at first.”

For Game Night, Demsky made a custom Guess Who board, put bobbleheads on Rock’em Sock’em robots and made custom Go Fish cards all to try and market our drivers and hopefully get more people interested in our sport.

When it comes to Demsky, people seem to agree that his future’s so bright, he’s gotta wear shades.

### Brandy Wine on fire since taking over from trainer John MacDonald

When a big opportunity presented itself, the young trainer took a deep breath and said to herself, “I can do this.”

Recollections of the precise moment, the one last year when she was asked to take over the string of standardbreds from trainer/driver John MacDonald, is still somewhat of a blur for Brandy Wine.

Understandable, especially when you consider MacDonald has over 5,000 wins combined and is still going strong.

“John basically handed over training to me,” said Wine. “One day, literally, he came up to me and said that he didn’t want to do the training side of things anymore. He said, ‘If you want to do it, it’s yours.’ I’ve been in the barn with him every day for the past three years, so I’ve been fortunate to learn a lot from him. That’s how I got those horses and owners, and it’s kind of been building from there.”

That would be somewhat of an understatement.

In her rookie season holding the training reins, Wine won 38 of 139 starts, posted 82 top-three finishes, accompanied by \$175,801 in purse earnings and a stellar .420 UTRS rating.

“I remember thinking, ‘This is a lot of pressure.’ When you have the type of horses we have, you need to be able to show the owners that you are capable of getting the best results out of them.”

Wine, who currently trains 12 horses, relied on past experiences to help her in the present.

“The way I learned to do things is a lot different from the way I do things now. I started in the barn when I was able to walk, being around my mother [Jill] and my father [Tom]. Every single summer, I had a grooming job for a different person. Three years ago, I ended up with John. I feel that every single person I’ve been able to work with has taught

me different things, skills that I’ve been able to apply to my own barn. Whatever the routine is now, it’s working for the horses.”

Crafting and creating a training identity of her own is far from complete.

Knowing she has plenty of support close at hand and more just a phone call away has been a source of comfort for Wine.

“Whenever I have a question, I can call my mother or my brother [Tee] and they have a great perspective, maybe different than mine. That is a huge help. Or I can call John, and ask for his advice. That’s really what helps me the most.”

Big success hasn’t come with an ego to match.

Instead, Wine is dialed-in on upping her game, eager to learn the ropes, open to other people’s advice, and focused on ensuring the horses are at their best when the starter car beings to roll.

The results speak for themselves.

“As for my biggest highlight – it might not sound like a big deal to others – but winning the open at Saratoga [Aug. 2, 2020] with my mare, Come Get The Cash, is my top moment



so far.”

Wine owns the 6-year-old daughter of Western Terror, who won five races, posted five seconds, and a third from 19 starts in 2020.

The 14-time winner has delivered several memorable moments for her owner-trainer, as has Lyons Johnny, a 13-year-old pacing son of Mach Three who she also owns.

“Come Get The Cash was the one that gave me my first win [July 16, 2020, at Vernon Downs], my first win at Pocono [Aug. 2, 2020], my first win at Saratoga [Aug. 18, 2020] and Shenandoah Downs [Oct. 16, 2020]. She shows up every single week. There’s just something about this mare... she does well everywhere she goes.”

Just like Wine, who has tracked success at racetracks across the United States, including a \$49,000 Florida Breeders Stakes victory with 3-year-old trotting filly Brasen Bo, last December at Pompano Park.

It’s fitting that on this day she’s pulling into Saratoga where she’ll have two qualify in the morning and three racing at night.

That she has been on the road early and will be back home late is nothing new for a horseperson that logs some serious miles throughout the year.

Wine has become used to long stretches of road and long days.

“Last year was just crazy. I was all over the place, literally. But it was great to get the opportunity to race at different places, get a feel of how your horses could compete at different racetracks. I think all of that time driving to those spots has really helped me.”

Some of that time behind the wheel is dedicated to thinking about her goals both in the short and long term.

“I love this industry. My goal for this year is to have a really good summer, to have the horses at their best, and to see that show up in their results. My bigger goal is to maybe end up at some place like Pocono and have some really nice horses to compete there. Last year, I tried Plainridge, Pocono and Yonkers – I did a little bit of everything each week just to see where I could really compete.

“I don’t really know where I want to end up. I kind of want to be closer to my family. They’re living in Pocono, so it would be nice if things could work out where I’m close by to them. For now, I’ll just focus on my horses and make sure I have them ready for wherever they race.”

Wine laughs when asked if her training career to date has exceeded her expectations.

“It’s a lot better than expected, to be honest with you. When I started, I wasn’t expecting to have as nice of horses that I have now. I think that’s the biggest part of it. The owners I have give me very, very nice horses, and I’m lucky that I have my parents, my brother, and John, to be there for me at any time. I feel very fortunate in so many ways.”

Ecurie D. became hot stuff for the tracks' managers after several great

## This Is The Plan swiftest in round four of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series

**This Is The Plan**, **Western Joe**, and **Leonidas A** scored victories in the trio of \$40,000 divisions of the fourth leg of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series on Monday night (April 5) at Yonkers Raceway. In addition to the on-track action, betting was also brisk on Monday's 10-race card as the handle entered seven-figure territory at \$1,037,217.95.

After finishing second in all three of his appearances in the series coming into this leg, **This Is The Plan** (Yannick Gingras) broke through for the first time in style, taking the opening split in 1:51.1. Gingras fired **This Is The Plan** to the top from post four, and he would put up fractions of :27.2, :56.1, and 1:23.3 before he closed in :27.3 to win by three lengths over pocket-sitter **Raukapuka Ruler N** (Jordan Stratton). **Mach N Cheese** (Joe Bongiorno) held third over favorite **Let It Ride N** (Dexter Dunn).

Ron Burke trains **This Is The Plan**, a 6-year-old gelding by **Somebeachsomewhere**, for owners Burke Racing Stable LLC., Weaver Brussemi LLC., J&T Silva- Purnel & Libby, and Larry Karr. **This Is The Plan** is now a 15-time winner in his career, and he pushed his earnings to \$1,806,700. **This Is The Plan**, the 3-2 second choice, paid \$5.00 and was atop a \$51.50 exacta and a \$126.50 trifecta.

In the second section, driver Todd McCarthy put the hammer down with **None Bettor A** and roared through stations of :26.3, :55.1, and 1:23.1. On the far turn **Sheriff N** (Daniel Dube) attacked the leader two-wide from the pocket, with favorite **Rockapelo** (George Brennan) picking up cover from third to sit second-over. Even though **Sheriff N** and **Rockapelo** had first dibs on the tiring leader, it wound up being a cavalry charge through the stretch after the hot tempo, and taking advantage was **Western Joe** (Dunn), who sat inside in sixth and rallied through a gap on the pylons on his way to the win by a neck in 1:52.4. **Rockapelo** wound up second, with **Sheriff N** back in third.

**Western Joe**, a 7-year-old gelded son of **Western Ideal**, scored his second straight victory in the series for trainer Chris Choate, co-owner/breeder Anthony Ruggeri, and co-owner Richard Tosies. **Western Joe** now has a record of 33-16-11 from 105 starts, and he has banked \$781,858. **Western Joe**, who was the second choice at odds of 5-2,

returned \$7.70 to win and keyed a \$15.60 exacta and a \$54.50 trifecta.

**Leonidas A** (Austin Siegelman), returning after a one-week break, ran his MGM Borgata Pacing Series record to an unblemished three-for-three in the final flight. **Leonidas A** settled in third behind **Ostro Hanover** (Tyler Buter) and **Lyons Steel** (Corey Callahan) in the early going, but Siegelman had him out and on move before the 28-second opening quarter went on the board, and he would take command after that marker. **Leonidas A** would go on to put up a 56.4 half and a 1:24.4 three-quarters, and a 28.3 final kicker gave him the victory by 2 1/4 lengths in 1:53.2. **Lyons Steel** was second after a first-over try, narrowly bettering **Ostro Hanover**.

A 6-year-old Mach Three gelding, **Leonidas A** is trained by Sheena Mcelhiney for owner Jesmeral Stable. **Leonidas A** posted his 28th career victory, and he has now put away \$291,848. **Leonidas A**, hammered down to 1-9, paid \$2.30 to win and led a \$7.90 exacta and a \$19.20 trifecta.

There is one more leg of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series to go, and that will be held next Monday (April 12). The final will take place on Monday, April 19.

Stakes action resumes at Yonkers tonight (April 9), with a couple of \$35,000 splits of the final preliminary round of the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series for pacing mares. In the non-wagering tilt, **Blue Ivy** (post one, Tyler Buter/Todd Buter) and **Machnhope** (post three, Andrew McCarthy/Noel Daley) will both shoot for their third win in the series, and in the other Blue Chip Matchmaker match-up, **Alexa Skye** (post four, Todd McCarthy/Jeff Cullipher), currently three-for-three in the event, meets up with one of last Friday's victors in **Siesta Beach** (post three, Matt Kakaley/Nick Devita).



## Fields drawn for final leg of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series

The preliminary rounds of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series conclude on Monday night (April 12) at Yonkers Raceway with three \$40,000 divisions in races four, five, and six.

The first section showcases three horses who have tasted success during the event in Backstreet Shadow (post one, Tim Tetrick), Lyons Steel (post five, Corey Callahan/Dennis Watson), and Western Joe (post six, Dexter Dunn/Chris Choate). Backstreet Shadow and Lyons Steel both have won once in the series, and Western Joe enters having won his last two appearances.

None of the entrants in race five's second split have picked up a victory in this year's MGM Borgata Pacing Series, so a new face will get a big boost to their point total. The horse that looks to be in the best form is Mach N Cheese (post three, Joe Bongiorno/Edwin Quevedo), as he has finished second and third the past couple of weeks.

In contrast to that tilt, the final flight (race six) features two horses that are both three-for-three in the series in Leonidas A (post one, Austin Siegelman/Sheena Mcelhiney) and Hesa Kingslayer N (post five, Jim Marohn Jr./Mike Deters). Also entered in that contest is This Is The Plan (post six, Yannick Gingras/Ron Burke), who has a record of 1-3-0 in four MGM Borgata Pacing Series efforts and prevailed in 1:51.1 on April 5.

## Get Legs returns to winning ways in John Brennan Trotting Series

**Get Legs** entered last week's opening round of John Brennan Trotting Series at Yonkers Raceway with eight wins in nine starts at the Meadowlands, but miscued over the sloppy going and had to settle for rallying for third. He made no such miscues this Wednesday (April 7), though, cruising to a 1:55.2 victory.

Driver Andy Miller didn't hustle Get Legs away from post two in Wednesday's final \$20,000 division, but he didn't tuck on the inside, either, letting his horse move steadily up on the rim to get the lead from Lady Jeter (Scott Zeron) after the :28.4 opening quarter. From there, Get Legs put up the half in :57.2 and the three-quarters in 1:26.2, navigated the far turn without any issue, and pulled away impressively in the lane on his way to defeating Lady Jeter by 5 1/2 lengths. P L Notsonice (Renaldo Morales III) came in third after a first-over try.

Julie Miller trains Get Legs, a 4-year-old son of Muscle Hill, for owners Andy Miller Stable Inc. and Michael Anderson. Get Legs has earned \$76,010 to go with his 9-0-2 record from 11 starts, and he paid \$2.10 across the board. The exacta returned \$4.70 and the trifecta was worth \$14.00.

In other John Brennan Trotting Series action, Tyler Buter had a pair of winners in Stinglike A B K and Timon AS.

Competing in the night's first split, **Stinglike A B K** raced in third through opening half fractions of :28.1 and 57.3, then made a first-over move past the half that carried him into second behind leader Swiss House Onfire (Austin Siegelman) at the 1:26.4 three-quarters. Stinglike A B K and Swiss House Onfire battled around the final bend and into the lane, but Stinglike A B K gained a narrow advantage and was able to hold sway to the wire, downing a gaining Lifetime Royalty (Dan Dube) by a neck in 1:56.3. Swiss House Onfire wound up third.

Stinglike A B K is a 5-year-old Andover Hall stallion owned and trained by Nicole Dicostanzo. Stinglike A B K is now a nine-time winner in his career, and he has banked \$97,054. Stinglike A B K, the 2-1 second choice, returned \$6.00 to win and was atop a \$45.40 exacta and a \$112.50 trifecta.

Two races later, Buter guided **Timon AS** to a 1:57 decision. Timon AS pocketed up behind Look In My Eyes (Jordan Stratton) and stalked that foe through a :29.1 opening quarter and a :58.1 half, then pulled out of the two-hole as they trotted to the 1:27.2 three-quarters. Timon AS wore down Look In My Eyes coming into the stretch, then drew clear, prevailing by a length and three-quarters. Look In My Eyes held second over Blue And Bold (Brent Holland).

A 5-year-old Lionhunter gelding, Timon AS is trained by Melanie Wrenn for owner Michael Guest. Timon AS now has a record of 20-3-1 from 55 attempts, and he has put away \$111,280. Timon AS was the 3-2 second choice and paid \$5.10 to win. The exacta kicked back \$59.00 and the trifecta was worth \$728.00.

Buter nearly nabbed another win with first-over attacker Grinder in the second section, but Windsong Pioneer (Holland), who put up stations of :27.3, :57.1, and 1:25.3, kept Grinder at bay in game fashion, hitting the wire a nose to the good in a 1:56.1 mile. Guilty Desire (Stratton) got third after a second-over journey.

The victorious 5-year-old E L Titan gelding is trained by Paul Stafford for owner Thomas Ceraso Jr. Windsong Pioneer picked up his 14th career win, and he boosted his bankroll to \$110,932. Windsong Pioneer, dispatched at 7-2, returned \$9.00 to win and led a \$24.40 exacta and a \$66.50 trifecta.

The John Brennan Trotting Series has one preliminary leg remaining next Wednesday, April 14, before the final on Wednesday, April 21.

## Don Tiger is 'real excited' for 2021 season with Charlie May

Don Tiger knows where Charlie May's 3-year-old season will begin. Where the pacer goes from there will be decided as his campaign unfolds, but the owner knows where he would like to see his horse: all around the Grand Circuit.

Charlie May, who was voted Ohio's best 2-year-old male pacer in 2020, makes his seasonal debut Saturday (April 10) in a \$15,000 elimination of the James K. Hackett Memorial for 3-year-old male pacers at Miami Valley Raceway. Charlie May, trained by Steve Carter, will start from post seven in a seven-horse field with driver Brett Miller.

Last year, Tiger's homebred gelding won seven of nine starts and finished second in both defeats. Charlie May earned \$328,627 to rank sixth among all 2-year-old male pacers in North America and his best win time of 1:50.2, established in a track-record Ohio Sire Stakes championship performance at Scioto Downs, tied for fifth.

Charlie May will be pointed toward events for Ohio-sired horses to begin the season, but Tiger has paid the horse into numerous open stakes for 3-year-old male pacers including the North America Cup, Meadowlands Pace, and Breeders Crown. He is not eligible to the Little Brown Jug but can be supplemented if he wins one of the following races: North America Cup, Meadowlands Pace, Messenger Stakes, or Cane Pace.

"We've got four weeks here (in Ohio) to find out where we're at," Tiger said. "The goal is to get better each week, and then at the beginning of May we'll have decisions to make as far as where we're going. I paid the money for everywhere. He's staked until the end of November. I did my part. Now it's going to be up to the horse."

"I'm real excited. You never know what is going to happen between (ages) 2 and 3, but I think the good thing for me is I've been playing with house money, so I'm calm and relaxed and excited and happy. I wouldn't trade places with anybody."

Charlie May is by McArdle out of Stipple Hanover. He is the first horse Tiger ever bred.

"I just took a leap of faith," Tiger said. "This is for the little guys. This isn't supposed to happen to Steve Carter and Don Tiger. It's a feel-good story. I own the horse, but he's not my



horse. It's those guys at the barn — Steve Carter and his staff. They've told me he's a one-in-a-million horse.

"I'd love for those local guys to get the chance (on the Grand Circuit). It would be great for them and great for Ohio racing."

Tiger plans to bring a realistic approach to determining Charlie May's stakes schedule.

"I want to make a stamp on the national scene, but I'm not going to go through it just to do it," he said. "I'm not going to go to the Meadowlands Pace to be 30-1 and hope I'm fifth. If we're going to those kinds of races we're going to go because we're bringing a howitzer. We're not going with a squirt gun."

"We'll see how it shakes out. I just want him to be healthy. If he's healthy and gets beat, I'm great with that. I just don't ever want to play the 'what if' game. If he's healthy, then it's just up to the racing gods and whatever is supposed to happen is going to happen."

Charlie May's opening assignment will not be easy. Among his Hackett rivals is Heart Of Chewbacca, who handed Charlie May a setback in a preliminary round of the Ohio Sire Stakes last year and was second in the final.

Heart Of Chewbacca, trained by Ron Burke and driven by Dan Noble, also is staked to numerous Grand Circuit races. He was one of last season's fastest 2-year-olds on both a five-eighths and half-mile track.

"Ohio has gotten tougher," Burke said. "I think you'll see that maybe those colts can step and go with the other ones. They're breeding a lot of horses; they're breeding way more quality. Things are heading in the right direction there."

Laughagain Hanover, who was third in the Ohio Sire Stakes championship, leads the first Hackett elimination. He is trained by Christi Noble and driven by Dan Noble.

The first-four finishers from each elimination will advance to the \$40,000 final April 17. They will be joined by the fifth-place horse with the fastest time.

## Standardbred Support Payments announced for April race card cancellations in Ontario

Ontario Racing is pleased to notify industry participants that standardbred horsepeople affected by the cancellation of race cards for Woodbine Mohawk Park (April 3, 2021), The Raceway at Western Fair District (April 3, 2021) and Rideau Carleton Raceway (April 4, 2021), due to the COVID-19 pandemic, will receive a one-time payment of \$300 for each horse drawn into race on the specified days.

The number of horses, 310 in total, affected by the cancellation of races due to the Ontario Government's latest lockdown measures put into effect on April 3, 2021, are as follows: Woodbine Mohawk Park – 103 horses, The Raceway at Western Fair District – 78 horses, and Rideau Carleton Raceway – 129 horses.

These funds were already committed to the industry through the Funding Agreement for Live Horse Racing between Ontario Racing and OLG. The support payments will be mailed out in the coming days.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Ontario Racing created a task force, as it did during the spring 2020 lockdown, to address the financial impacts to standardbred horse racing in Ontario.

## New directors added to Hambletonian Society board

At the Annual Winter Meeting of the Directors of the Hambletonian Society David H. Anderson, Ernest M. Gaskin and David H. McDuffee were appointed to fill vacancies on the Society board.

The new appointments, created by the retirement and subsequent election to director emeriti status of long-time Society directors Dr. J. Glen Brown, E.T. Gerry Jr. and Charles

Keller III, were approved on March 28 at the Society virtual Winter Board meeting.

David Anderson is a breeder and owner from Aurora, ON whose most recent ownership interests include 2020 Little Brown Jug winner Captain Barbossa. He and his father, Bob Anderson, a former Hambletonian Society director, started the filly Pampered Princess, a winner of \$1,648,362, in the 2007 Hambletonian against the colts, winning an elimination of the classic trotting race. They also owned 2003 Hambletonian Oaks winner Southwind Allaire. Anderson owns Phoenix Performance Products, an equine safety equipment company and was recently named to Ontario Racing Board of Directors.

Ernie Gaskin, of Anderson, IN rose to prominence as an assistant trainer for the dynastic W.R. Haughton Stable, whose dominant presence in the early years of the Breeders Crown helped make the series an instant classic with champions like Nihilator, Caressable, Naughty But Nice and Peace Corps. That priceless foundation took Gaskin to Indiana, where he owns, trains, breeds and races standardbreds, as well as stands stallions at his Crimson Lane Farm. He was appointed by the Governor in 1994 to the Standardbred Breed Development Advisory Commission as one of the early advocates for the future of harness racing in the Hoosier State. The work of that commission shaped the legislation that brought pari-mutuel racing to the state. Some 25 years later Indiana-breds compete on the national stage, and have won multiple divisional honors, including Dan Patch Horse of the Year. Additionally, Hoosier Park has hosted the Breeders Crown to record-breaking events on two occasions.

Long-time insurance man Dave McDuffee of Delray Beach, FL, has his father to thank for his 50-year involvement in harness racing. His friendship with partner Tom Walsh and their success with 1994 Little Brown Jug and Breeders Crown champion Magical Mike sealed the deal for McDuffee. More recently, McDuffee was co-owner of Hambletonian Oaks champion filly trotter Bee A Magician, who won \$4.2 million and authored an undefeated 2013 Horse of the Year season, as well as the star-crossed pacing colt Papi Rob Hanover.

"Charlie Keller, Glen Brown and Ebby Gerry have contributed so much both to the sport and to the Society that they are truly irreplaceable," said John Campbell, president and CEO of the Hambletonian Society.

"All have left a lasting legacy with the Society. We welcome the new directors to the board and we feel their commitment and knowledge of our sport will have significant impact with the Society as we move forward."



In other business, the racing conditions of Breeders Crown No. 36 and Hambletonian No. 98 were approved with additional integrity language to accept yearling payments of May 15, 2021.

## **Low takeouts mean big action at Big M**

Business at The Meadowlands continued its remarkable early stages of 2021 run, as after a highly-successful first quarter, action at the mile oval stayed vigorous as the second quarter kicked off last weekend with a pair of \$3-million handles, upping the total number of race cards that have surpassed that magic number to 18 on the year.



During all of 2020, the \$3-million barrier was broken a total of 11 times.

Much of the success The Big M has experienced can be attributed to the half-dozen popular wagers offered nightly that offer a low takeout of 15 per cent. A prime example is last weekend's action in the extremely popular Pick-4, when the bet – which is offered four times every weekend – took in a total of \$367,866 of action, an average per pool of \$91,966.

Meadowlands management is convinced that when you return more to the bettors, the more bettors will bet.

"All of us at The Meadowlands feel that low takeout is a key component in bringing horseplayers of all breeds to wager on our track," said track chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemoir. "The Big M offers six chances a night to play into low 15 per cent takeout pools. Another significant reason to the play The Meadowlands is that we offer only one wager (the trifecta, 25 per cent) that has a takeout higher than 20 per cent. Judging by our rapidly growing business this year, players around the world seem very appreciative for the built-in value created by our price-conscious wagering menu."

Here is the takeout breakdown at the Big M:

- 15 per cent: 50-cent Pick-4, 20-cent Pick-5, 20-cent Pick-6, 20-cent Survivor Pick-7, 10-cent Pentafecta/Hi-5
- 17 per cent: Win, Place and Show
- 19 per cent: Exacta, Daily Double
- 20 per cent: Pick-3, 10-cent Superfecta
- 25 per cent: Trifecta

Saturday night saw betting total \$3,444,133, with two popular multi-leg bets showing big returns, with the Pick-4 averaging \$101,770 per pool while the first race Pick-5 saw action of \$82,960. The ever-reliable exacta, which is available on every race, averaged \$72,997, accounting for almost \$950,000 of action on the night, more than one quarter of the total handle.

Some potent payoffs from last weekend included Friday's Early Pick-4 (\$3,556), Survivor (\$15,231) and Pentafecta/Hi-5 (\$1,224). Saturday's big payouts came in the Pick-5 (\$1,632), Survivor (\$6,506) and Pick-6 (\$12,209).

FINAL DERBY PREP: The last prep for the May 1 Kentucky Derby is on Saturday (April 10) as the \$1-million Arkansas Derby takes place at Arkansas' Oaklawn Park. The card will be offered as part of an extensive simulcasting menu at The Meadowlands.

The Oaklawn card has a post time of 1 p.m. with the

Arkansas Derby slated to go as race 12 at 7:41 p.m. The horse to beat is the Joel Rosario-ridden, Bob Baffert-trained Concert Tour, who is the even-money morning-line favorite. There are four stakes events on the 13-race program that feature purses of at least \$250,000.
