Meeting in the middle over enforcement of The Meadowlands' driving rules

Management of The Big M and its drivers met Friday to discuss amending the new rules. Trainer Ron Burke and track owner Jeff Gural said both sides are happy with the compromises made that averted a possible strike by the horsepeople.

A meeting was held Friday (April 7) at The Meadowlands following morning qualifiers to discuss the enforcement and punishment of specific rules being overseen by judge Lou Haskell.


As reported in this column two weeks ago, Haskell was hired by The Meadowlands' president/chief executive officer Jeff Gural to enforce four specific rules and dispense strict punishment in a fair and impartial manner.

According to The Meadowlands' leading trainer Ron Burke, the horsepeople talked amongst themselves a week ago — the day Haskell started — but Burke was not in favor of a pre-emptive strike.

"We had already talked before the races last week, a bunch of us," Burke said. "Should we do it — even before they were racing — and say, 'No we're just not going out.' And I said, 'Yannick [Gingras], it's hard to draw a line in the sand when they haven't showed you where the line is.' My thought was go out there, race and then when you see it, we'll know. If they're making the correct calls or calls that we can all live with, then you let

it go, but when a kid wins a race — and he's not one of the big kids — and gets called in, no shot.

"As a trainer, if my guy won the race and you're calling him in, you're basically telling him to drive [my horse] differently next



"I'm putting the best horse in front of me and when he moves, I'm going to move with him. Or, I'm going to try and get him to move and then he's going to put me right into the race. I had a problem when horses were asked to give up winning moves."

Had it come to a strike — unlike other professional sports where strikes have not resulted in the players getting everything they wanted and largely resulted in alienating fans — Burke thinks it could have worked in the favor of The Meadowlands drivers because they are The Meadowlands drivers.

"I always say if the first 10 idiots quit, we'll get 10 more idiots to drive, but the truth is one thing we all love about The Meadowlands is if you get a bad driver there now, it's because you wanted one," Burke said. "Because there are plenty available to pick a good one. You can go 10 guys deep easily where you have total confidence. It's the only track where if you got a bad driver, it's because you wanted a bad driver."

It's rare when both sides can leave the bargaining table happy, but that is what sources say happened.

Although Haskell's rulings were not made public yet, the "kid" Buke is referring to, allegedly won a race last weekend yet was still given a warning for a move he made in that race.

"If you won the race, obviously, what you did was the right thing," Burke said. "You're not out there to make the racing better, you're out there to win. That's your number one thing, win. Will people bet a product when drivers are making moves that are non-winning moves?"

Burke went on to say that he supports Gural regarding "courtesy tucks."

"I get where Jeff is coming from as far as that," Burke said. "I'm the one guy that will say that I can't stand the giving holes and stuff. If it's a 30-1 guy dropping in a 10-1 guy and neither of them pull, I've got no problem [with penalizing them]. We all know it when we see it. 

Ultimately, Burke didn't think it would ever come to a strike, because, as he's always said, Gural will listen to what you have to say.

"I'm pro Jeff," Burke said. "I'm not against Jeff. Do I agree with him on everything? No. And I think Yannick is the same way. Jeff is reasonable when you talk to him... Jeff is not an unreasonable person and neither is Yannick and most of the drivers. Sometimes, I think Jeff gets ahead of himself, or maybe loses his way, but he probably thinks the same about us, too. But it's been a good partnership. It's the one place where I always feel like it's a professional game there.

"You can't tell guys they can't make moves that they think are winning moves. True gamblers know what they're watching. It's a very intricate dance, basically. They agreed on money fines, which \$250 probably doesn't hurt them that bad, but don't tell me \$500 or \$1,000 won't change behavior. It'll change behavior. I've always said we never needed all these new rules. We had the right rules, we just needed to enforce them. Ten years ago, I said, 'We all know it when we see it.'"

Hennessey reflects on Pompano, looks to Northfield Drivers Challenge

Today marks one year, nearly to the exact date, in which Pompano Park played host to its final race card. Demolition is formally underway on the Pompano Park grandstand. For Hall of Famer and all-time great Wally Hennessey, this past winter was an unfamiliar looking one.

"I knew heading back down in the middle of November that it was going to be rough, to not be competing, to not have Pompano," said Hennessey. "I mean, I knew it was over, I realized it, but I don't know if it's something I'll ever get over. Here we are a year later and it's just not something that you accept easily."

Though not competing this winter, Hennessey has still kept busy in south Florida.

"What helped me kind of get through that part was that I had gotten some babies to work with," said Hennessey. "Trond Smedshammer had sent me down eight baby trotters for the winter, so that's kind of what I've been doing all winter here at Sunshine Meadows, training some babies."

Far from missing only the racing aspect of Pompano, Hennessey's feelings run deeper.

"I've always considered Pompano my home after the first year or two starting here in the 1980s," said Hennessey. "We've had friendships not just inside the business but outside the business. My wife and daughter teach in school, so this is where we've kind of planted our garden, you could say. It's still going to be the winter place for us, and I think, even if I had stayed up north this year or raced a little longer, it still wouldn't have been the same as the years that I've spent down here.

"For me and many other people who were here for a long time, it's about all these friendships and camaraderie that were formed. The owners, trainers, drivers, the backstretch, everything.



The businesses around here, everybody knew your name, it was a family type of feeling."

One year after fittingly closing out Pompano Park with a win in the last race ever at the track, what Hennessey describes is a far different picture than most tracks today. Though Pompano hasn't been family operated since its Van Lennep and Castleton Farm days, the track managed to maintain a different, more personal feel, than the commercially owned racino tracks of today.

"One of the major reasons for that, is that we continued to have our own stabling area," Hennessey said. "For the most part, for the last 10 to 20 years, better than 50 per cent of the stable area were the same individuals year in and year out. And there were many others that came and tried, believe me. But better than 50 per cent of the backstretch has remained the same over that time. The same outfits, same colony of drivers, it was truly a big family, and we had a great thing going.

"I'd also be remiss if I didn't say something about Gabe (Prewitt). What he and his entire team had done for Pompano was next to a miracle. He took us from the bottom floor to the penthouse, and his whole team sent Pompano out as gracefully as it could have possibly gone out."

Not surprisingly, this upcoming week's Northfield vs. Pompano two-day Drivers Challenge hosted at Northfield Park on Tuesday (April 11) and Wednesday (April 12) was Prewitt's idea. And following a winter without racing for the first time in his career, Hennessey can't wait to get back at it this upcoming week in the challenge.

"I'm really looking forward to the Drivers Challenge, to represent Pompano for another time, and I'm anxious to get back going. It's for a good cause, and win, lose or draw we're hoping for some fun and safe trips," said Hennessey. "I haven't been racing, but I'm going to get a little warmup (Friday) because we have some qualifiers at Sunshine Meadows. So I'm going to get my feet wet a little."

Since we spoke, Hennessey won three of his six qualifiers that morning at Sunshine Meadows in advance of his trek to Northfield Park.

A winner of 11,454 career races, only a sparse number of those have come from Northfield Park. Hennessey has been in Ohio prior, but in the distant past.

"I can't tell you the exact year I was there last, but it was many moons ago," said Hennessey. "Generally, I was a Pompano man in the wintertime half the year, and when I did go up north, I was kind of an East Coast guy, mainly New York and Pennsylvania. But I was fortunate enough there one time though when I won that big race there, The Battle of Lake Erie way back in the '90s with Cambest."

The 1993 performance was a then track record of 1:52.3.

Joining Hennessey on Team Pompano will be Dave Miller, Peter Wrenn and Joseph Chindano, Jr. They will square off against Team Northfield, consisting of Aaron Merriman, Ronnie Wrenn Jr., Chris Lems and Billy Davis, Jr.

Racing revolutionaries at Rooster's Roadhouse

Could an NCAA bracket-inspired series of short match races help harness racing?

"I got another idea, you know, for harness horse racing."

My pal Duke groaned, "Not another one," and grabbed a handful of popcorn from a red plastic basket on the bar at Rooster's Roadhouse."

"Seriously, I've been thinking about this idea a lot."

Duke slowly swiveled his bushy head towards me and said, "The more you think about something, the worse it usually gets for the rest of us, especially those who like the sport just the way it is."

Ignoring him, I asked, "Do you remember years ago, in the winter Olympics, there was that kid named Apolo Ohno, a short track speedskater? I'm not sure why they even called it speedskating because the racers just cruised around the oval track, taking turns leading the race, deking, feinting and then, wham, a wild rush to the finish line."

Duke nodded. "I do remember those races. I also remember bicycle races where the riders did the same sort of thing in the summer Olympics. for a quick rest. Although he will not be tired because he only raced a lap, probably not at maximum speed."

Duke took a slug of his Bud Light and looked at the paper with the brackets. I could tell by his lack of snide comments that I had his attention. He asked, "What about the start? Do they use a car?"

"No, not necessary. Both must be within a neck at the start of the race."

"Yep, the match races follow each other quickly. The first round will probably take less than 15 minutes. Then it is on to round two. Two races, two winners go forward, two losers earn \$2,000 and go home."

He asked, "Could people wager on the individual matches or just the winner of the final?"

I took a sip and thought for a minute, "I don't see why people couldn't wager on both."

"What's the purse?"

"I don't know, Duke, this is hypothetical. We are engineering in a new frontier, pioneering a new paradigm, going where no man has gone before, and saving the sport of harness racing."

He chuckled and said, "We are slinging manure after three beers, but you know Trey, you have had worse ideas. You have had hundreds of worse ideas, you have a bad idea every day, but there are a lot of pluses with this one."

He ticked them off on his fingers as he said, "The action would be fast. The horses would not race down to their knees and human beings are much more important in races like these. There would be plenty of wagering angles, new and casual gamblers would not need to know much and photo finishes almost every race. No dreadful post positions, no starting car, safer..."

I interrupted him. "Whoa, whoa, Duke, I haven't seen you this excited since the Judge denied alimony to your second wife."

We clinked beer bottles.

We thought briefly, then Duke asked, "Ever see this kind of race happening?"

"Probably not. Traditionalists would get the vapors. Match racing harness horses would be too much of a shock to existing systems. Maybe, conceivably, there is a slight chance that an enterprising racetrack could run a match race contest like we are talking about before or after a regular race program on an experimental basis, sort of a prototype."

"I'll tell you what, my man. Old Duke would watch them races and bet a few dollars. I can't believe you finally came up with an idea with legs."

We clinked again.

Once Paige Usiak found harness racing all she wanted to do was share it with everyone

The irony isn't lost on Paige Usiak.

"I grew up 15 minutes away from Buffalo Raceway," Usiak said. "I've lived in the city my whole life and I never knew that harness racing was a thing. I didn't know we had a racetrack in Buffalo. I've always been obsessed with horses since I can remember, but living in the city, I didn't have access to that. Now, I do and it's my goal to find those people like me. They exist."

Usiak is the marketing coordinator for Buffalo Raceway, a role she has held for the past four years.

How it came to be is far from a traditional tale for the Buffalo native, whose curiosity with the standardbred industry grew exponentially around five years ago.

"It's actually a pretty interesting story," she said. "When I was around 18, I got a job at a feed store and I thought this would be the way to make connections with the people that have the horses, the people I want to work with. If anyone came in to buy horse feed, I'd ask them if they needed help, if they needed someone to clean stalls."

Those near daily interactions eventually led her to the backstretch.

"I got my first job working around horses as a groom with standardbred racehorses," Usiak said. "From there it just kind of took off. There was a job opening to clean the ship-in barn at Buffalo Raceway and I took that position. I did that for about a year and it just opened more doors for me."

Plenty of them, in fact.

"Aside from the marketing coordinator position, I also own a couple of standardbreds," she said. "The days that I'm not doing the marketing role, I'm out jogging horses."

The perks are plentiful.

Perhaps the most treasured part of Usiak's racing career is the variety she experiences each day she's at the racetrack.

Tedium is never an issue.

"I love doing it all," Usiak said. "I love to learn new things and that would be my favorite part of what I do. You meet someone new every day and you learn something new every day. It's just incredible. There is nothing else I would rather do. I love my job so much. To interact with horses in one way or another is fantastic. And there are so many amazing horse people at Buffalo

Raceway. We're starting to grow again. We are starting to see a lot of new faces. It's so cool to connect with these people, to hear their stories and then tell them."

Usiak embraces any chance to sit in the race bike.

"I'm just happy when I do that," she said. "I have a couple that I really love to jog. Proven Desire, who was bred in PEI [Prince Edward Island], he's one of my favorite horses. He's in the barn of my trainer. He's just so happy to jog and do his job. All the horses I jog love what they do and you're just happy when you're out there. Nothing else really matters when you are in that moment. You forget about everything."

Watching the pacer that she co-owns with trainer James Clouser compete at her hometown track is also a thrill ride for Usiak.

She claimed the 6-year-old daughter of Mach Three last November at Batavia Downs.

"This is the second standardbred that I bought," Usiak said. "I'm hoping to have some success with her. She's a lot of fun, a lot easier to handle than the first one I bought. My first one was a roan and there is that thought where the grey ones can be a little crazy. And he was definitely that."

Keeping pace with all her duties, some official, others she has taken on herself, makes for a busy day and night at the racetrack.

All of it, however, is done with Usiak fashioning a big smile.

"I started a horseman of the month award last year and I've taken it a step further," she said. "We do interviews now. It's just really rewarding to shine the light on the horse people. I want people to see what I see every day, so many great stories and such an interesting sport."

A sport she is grateful to have found.

Usiak, who owns a gray Paint which she shows at ranch classes in Western New York, remains committed to bringing new faces into the harness racing fold, whether they are seated in the grandstand or working on the backstretch.

"Really, you don't have to be a fan of horses," Usiak said. "It's so amazing to hear how people ended up where they are in the business. It's a unique industry. It's actually very inclusive, where everyone can find something to be part of. You don't even have to have experience with horses. I just hired a groom for my trainer who has never touched a horse. And she's doing great.

"If there's anything I've learned — I never saw any of this coming — it's that setting long-term goals isn't for me. I take things day-to-day and just keep an open mind. I went to school for architecture and now I'm in marketing. I want to do something that makes me happy and I'm doing that right now. I feel like sometimes if you have a long-term goal, it can close doors for you. I guess my long-term goal is to do something that makes me happy and that's where I am right now."

When she's not at the racetrack or in the sulky, Usiak can often be found with a paint brush or pencil in hand, crafting artwork in a quiet corner of her home.

"I like to paint," Usiak said. "I do landscapes, horses and some other things. I also like to draw cartoons. I live a pretty active lifestyle, so sometimes it's nice to be able to sit back in a corner of the house and do some painting or a little doodle. I don't really share them with anybody, but it's a little different."

Crafting something personally rewarding, in a humble way, just seems to come naturally for Usiak.

Whether it's artwork or office work, creating something fulfilling, for herself and others, remains a top priority.

"I'm not unique," she said. "I know there are a lot more horse-obsessed people out there, who don't realize just how wonderful this sport is. I want to help find them and introduce them to it. I found it and I feel so fortunate that I did."





Champion driver Chris Alford is a competitive beast

Despite almost 40 years in the sulky, Chris Alford — the most successful driver in Down Under history — is still hungry to scale new heights.

That was abundantly clear recently when Alford, who turns 55 next month, confirmed he would cross the ditch to drive in New Zealand's richest race, the \$1-million Race by Grins slot at Cambridge on Friday (April 14).

He's still a man in demand.

Alford first agreed to head to Cambridge to drive one of Australia's best trotters, Aldebaran Zeus, in the first of a few

planned feature races for trainer Brent Lilley.

As soon as word spread, those connected with Triple Eight pounced on the opportunity to book Alford.

Although trips to New Zealand have been rare for the Victorian-based Alford, one of them provided the defining win of his career.

Wind the clock back to 1995 and the Christchurch Inter Dominion final at Addington.

Alford, then starting to make some serious headlines in Australia, propelled his career into the stratosphere when he stormed around the field behind Golden Reign to beat one of the greatest lineups the Inter Dominion final has ever assembled.

Best known as a stayer and for racing on the speed, Alford stunned rivals by sitting back and unleashing Golden Reign down the back straight the last time. I wanted to drive Aldebaran Zeus in New Zealand was because of the Rowe Cup. It's a great race with so much history. I love my trotters; they've been such a big part of my career and dad [the late Barry Alford] always had trotters. The Rowe Cup is one of the great trotting races in our part of the world. To then pick-up the drive on Triple Eight as well is a bonus?

In his wake were a list of Hall of Fame pacers and Inter Dominion heroes and mega race winners such as Chokin, Blossom Lady, Master Musician, Weona Warrior, Desperate Comment, Young Mister Charles and Bee Bee Cee.

"I've had some wonderful moments through the years, but it's definitely one I go back to as much as any of them," Alford said. "He was a great horse, Golden Reign. He did so much, but he was injured in his prime and didn't come back anywhere near as well after it. That was the sad part.

"Everyone got to see how good he was that day. Look back at the horses he beat. It was a field of stars. Probably the strongest Inter Dominion final I've driven in, maybe one of the best of all time. The top Kiwi drivers had been coming to Australia and winning our biggest races, so it meant a lot to go over there and beat them, especially beating that sort of field with the first great horse I'd driven. He's right up with the best I've driven."

Little did he know at the time, but Alford had to wait another 20 years to win his second and only other Inter Dominion final since. That was with one of the other great pacers he's been associated with, the quirky but gifted Lennytheshark.

"I kept getting asked who was better... I'm just lucky to have had them both in my career," Alford said.

While Alford has won most big races, the Race by Grins — in just its second year — and next month's Group 1 Rowe Cup for trotters are ones he would love to add to his bulging CV.

"To be honest, the main reason I wanted to drive Aldebaran Zeus in New Zealand was because of the Rowe Cup," Alford said. "It's a great race with so much history. I love my trotters; they've been such a big part of my career and dad [the late Barry Alford] always had trotters. The Rowe Cup is one of the great trotting races in our part of the world. To then pick-up the drive on Triple Eight as well is a bonus."

Alford hasn't driven in NZ that many times, but he has been to Cambridge before.

"Way back when I was a junior, I drove there and a few years back I took the top young trotter we had called Wobelee across for the Harness Jewels," he said. "Obviously I've got fond memories of New Zealand because of Golden Reign, but I'll always treasure winning the Great Northern Oaks in Auckland with Lombo La Fe Fe [in 2002].

"Even when we ran second in the 2003 Inter Dominion final with Mont Denver Gold in Christchurch... that was special because dad and I trained him together and I drove him. We just found Baltic Eagle too good that night, but he ran a great race."

While the big wins have been plentiful and memorable, Alford's greatest mark on the sport has been his sheer dominance with his volume of wins, year after year.

He's rapidly closing in on 8,000 wins. At last check, Alford had just edged past 7,830 wins so the 8,000th should come early next year at his current strike rate.

The closest anyone is to that in Australia is the late Gavin Lang's 6,303.

It's a mind-blowing dominance and one which has seen Alford win the Australian Driving Premiership a thumping 14 times: the first in 1994 and the most recent in 2020. Queenslander Pete McMullen has won the past two.

Alford also holds the record for the most wins in a single season with his 456 in 2017-18.

His brightest hopes for the rest of 2023 sit with trotters Aldebaran Zeus and his stablemate, the brilliant mare Queen Elida.

"[Lilley] has done a great job with both of them," Alford said. "They came through the big 2- and 3-year-old races together and always looked like they'd go on and be open-aged stars. Queen Elida has come a long way quickly. She's got the brilliance, while Aldebaran Zeus is tough and more of a front-runner.

"I've said before Queen Elida is as fast as any trotter I've driven at her top. She's got it all ahead of her. Aldebaran Zeus showed how good he is in front when he easily beat Just Believe in the Group 1 at Menangle a couple of runs back. Just Believe is the benchmark in Australia right now. If he gets some draws and has some luck in NZ, he's certainly good enough to win one of the big ones over there."

Alford will be hoping that big one is a race he loves, the Rowe Cup at Auckland's Alexandra Park on May 27.

It would be yet another chapter in a phenomenal career.







Tight win for Etonnant in Prix Kerjacques at Vincennes

Richard Westerink-trained **Etonnant** (Timoko) tried his luck among several top trotters when the \$125,000 Prix Kerjacques was contest at Vincennes on Saturday (April 8). And the title defender of the Elitloppet showed that he still can compete on his highest level against the elite.

Etonnant didn't get an easy first kilometer in the Prix Kerjacques. Anthony Barrier had a pretty bad start with Westerink's horse and Etonnant had to follow three wide during the race's first section. When Hussard du Landret hit the lead after a kilometer, Barrier found space second over where Etonnant could rest until the end of the uphill part of Vincennes' track. When the three wide attack began, Etonnant easily disarmed leader Hussard du Landret, but strong finishers Hokkaido Jiel and Usain Töll challenged the new leader at the top of the stretch. Etonnant seemed beaten with 100 meters to go. Usain Töll finished most strongly of the two challengers, but on the inside, Etonnant came back and claimed the trophy in a strong mile rate of 1:54.3 over 1.6 miles.

Usain Töll was second and Hokkaido Jiel third.

Prix Kerjacques replay.

GOCCIADORO SHOW IN KARLSTAD

Alessandro Gocciadoro's spring tour in the Nordic countries in Europe has begun and on Friday afternoon (April 7), his horses impressed a lot as the Italian trainer and driver claimed the two biggest races on the card.

Färjestad racetrack in Karlstad, Sweden, plays host to the traditional Easter races on the Friday and Gocciadoro started



his race day by being runner up behind Elitloppet invited **San** Moteur (Panne de Moteur) with his Bengurion Jet. Bengurion Jet was the early leader of the race and Björn Goop took over that position with a lap to go. San Moteur looked fresh and sound as he cruised to a safe win in his first start since August last year.

Then the Gocciadoro show began and when the 5-year-old mares battled in the \$35,000 Folke Hjalmarssons Minneslopp, the trainer showed the racing fans that he hasn't come back to Sweden without ammunition. Clarissa (Exploit Caf) came from Italy with a good reputation and despite having post nine, Gocciadoro wanted to be in the front at an early stage with his horse. Clarissa pushed hard on leader Faeza Zet during the race's last kilometer and in the last turn, Clarissa more or less had settled the race. She flew home in a very strong mile rate of 1:52.3 over 1.3 miles. It is doubtful there is any better 5-year-old mare in Europe at this time. Clarissa will be heard of many times again this summer, that's for sure.

In the \$65,000 Prins Carl Philips Jubileumspokal, open for all 5-year-olds, Iznoqoud Am made an interesting comeback. Stefan P Petterssons' trotter was involved in a very fast opening. where leader Seven Nation Army (American bred and trained in USA by Ray Schnittker) and driver Bo Westergaard were determined to keep the lead. A:26 guarter is nothing common in Swedish races, but Seven Nation Army was pushed to hit that mark by outside horse Iznogoud Am and the guick opening opened up for Gocciadoro's Jimmy Ferro B.R. (Love You), who controlled the race from outside the leader when Iznoqoud Am opted for a pocket trip after 500 meters.

Seven Nation Army showed that he is brave enough to fight back when Jimmy Ferro B.R. tried to get advantage of the race at the top of the stretch, but Gocciadoro's horses claimed the two big trophies on the card as Jimmy Ferro B.R. won in 1:51.4 over 1,640 meters.

Seven Nation Army deserves a gold star for his achievement in the race as the runner-up.

Kelley McNiven – Fourth generation horsewoman

Kelley McNiven is following in her parent's footsteps as well as carving out a path of her own.

McNiven's parents, Scott and Kim McNiven, were carrying on

their family's harness racing legacy when she was born. Scott's father, Bob, owned and raced harness horses in Ontario and after Bob's passing, his wife, Verna, continued her husband's love with their son, Scott.

Scott's brothers, Jack and (the late) Don, ran the notable breeding farm Killean Acres where they stood their stallion Run The Table and Scott's brother, Rob, founded the standardbred nursery Twinbrook Farm.

Located in Embro, ON, Twinbrook Farm is home to nearly 100 horses running on 130 acres of land. It is known for bringing the "Twin B" prefix to the North American harness racing industry and is now operated by Rob and Tammy McNiven's daughter Jenna McNiven. Though, Rob and Tammy are still very much involved.

Their family tree sprouts widely as Jenna's boyfriend, Francis Dumochel, is also horse trainer and cousin, Maddie Henry, is married to top driver/trainer Travis Henry, who notched his 2,000 driving win in 2022.

On Kelley's maternal side, her mother Kim got involved in the business through her father, Wayne Heywood. Wayne and his brother, Ross, both operated small training stables.

Kim's brother, Doug Heywood, presently owns racehorses with Scott and Kim.

With all that family involvement, it's no surprise that Kelley joined in.

"I have owned standardbreds since I was 10 years old," Kelley said. "My first horse was Jump For Joy: an appropriate name for I was always jumping for joy when I was around him. Another favorite racehorse was Kendal Fresco, who after he was done racing, he became a family pet.

"I also own a broodmare with my dad named Alphabet Queen. She is very special for I picked her out at a sale and looked after her during most of her racing career. Alphabet Queen had a beautiful Betterthancheddar filly named Baby Belle and is due again to foal the end of March a full sister or brother for Belle."

Today, Kelley works part-time with the horses. She is also employed as a behavioral technician/ABA therapist working with autistic children in an ABA therapy center. She is also a full-time student at Western University going for her MBA in the Applied Behavior Analysis program.

"I am so grateful I have the opportunity to do both as I am very passionate about my work in the ABA and still involved with the horses," she said.

Born in London, ON and raised in Putnam, ON, Kelley's family races mainly at The Raceway at The Western Fair District in London. During the summer, their horses race at Grand River Raceway and Clinton Raceway.

"I do not do well in the bitter cold, which is why I'm lucky to have an indoor job during the winter months," Kelley said. "This winter has been especially difficult for horsemen and the horses as many tracks were cancelled due to the inclement weather. You really must monitor the track condition for the safety of yourself, and especially the horses.

"During COVID I was finishing my undergraduate in family studies and psychology online through Western University, so I was able to work more in the barn for my parents. My father let me help him train. I loved being an integral part of the family business and learning as much as I could from my dad. It was so fulfilling to see the horses I helped train go back to the races and be successful. I also take as many catch paddocks as I can for other trainers, such as Nifty Norman, Anthony Haughan and Meg Crone. They are all great horsemen to work and learn from."

Over the years Kelley has had several favorite horses.

"Kendal Fresco has always been special to me," she said. "We bought him as a yearling in 2009, so we have had him most of his life. He taught me so much and I guess you could say he is, "My Heart Horse" for he's always been there for me: even for four of my graduations. Alphabet Queen is another favorite. I picked her out as a yearling and she was always a great mare to work with. And last, but not least, is Ride Away Shark, one of our broodmares who did well for us in her racing career.

"Currently my parents own a racehorse named Mr. Cheeseman (Betterthancheddar) who everyone knows as one of my babies' for he is super spoiled and I always try to personally take him on race night. He is the reason I bred my broodmare to Betterthancheddar."

Kelley also has a few standout choices from her catch paddock, with her favorite being the mare, Fire Start Hanover.

"Nifty Norman trained her and although she was difficult to work with, I loved her sassy attitude," Kelley said. "She was always game on the track and gave her all. I am eternally grateful for the opportunities I have had looking after Nifty's horses for he is one of the best trainers in the sport.

"My favorite horse in the Haughan/Crone Stable is their homebred 2-year-old Some Might Say. They are both amazing horse people and overall great humans. I still work for them, mostly on Saturdays."

The fastest horse the McNivens have owned is Ride Away Shark who won at Mohawk in 1:50.1. As a 2-year-old, Ride Away Shark won an Ontario Sires Stakes at Mohawk in 1:53, which in the year 2014, was considered extremely fast for a 2-year-old.

Not only is Kelley a fourth-generation horsewoman and avid horse lover, but the young woman has some big things ahead of her.

"My plans are to graduate with my master's degree in 2024 and continue my education in the ABA field," Kelley said. "My dream is to one day own a therapy center dedicated to the use of ABA therapy and equine-assisted therapy. I would love to be able to combine both of my passions. I'll also continue to breed my broodmare and hopefully her foals will make it to the track and be successful."







Drama Act returns to winning ways in Blue Chip Matchmaker Series

Defending Blue Chip Matchmaker Series champion **Drama Act** regained winning form in one of three \$40,000 splits of the fourth leg on Friday night (April 7) at MGM Yonkers Raceway after landing in a division without Amazing Dream N.

With George Brennan in the bike, Drama Act scored her fifth victory in eight 2023 starts with a 1:53 mile.

With the pole position Brennan didn't get assertive early and instead allowed Man Dontforget Me to cross over into the first turn. Delitfulcatherin N and Wahs Fire Bug N both had thoughts of getting the front at the outset, with the Jordan Stratton-driven Delitfulcatherin N going forward on the opening bend and Wahs

Fire Bug N retreating after a brief leaving move. Delitfulcatherin N cleared the lead before the quarter, but within an instant Brennan moved Drama Act with purpose and took control shortly past the :26.4 opening quarter.

Sent off as the prohibitive 1-20 favorite, Drama Act was able to back the half to :56.4 before Gia's Surreal, with Dexter Dunn, began a methodical first-over assault. Off a reasonable 1:25.1 three-quarters the outer tier disappeared into the final turn and only Delitfulcatherin N had a chance to run down the favorite. Under left handed urging by Stratton, the 7-year-old looked to gain momentum to pass Drama Act, but Brennan's mare had something in reserve and prevailed with a :27.4 final quarter. Delitfulcatherin N settled for second, with early leader Man Dontforget Me third.

Now with two wins and a second in four series starts, Drama Act assured herself a position in the April 24 final with the victory for trainer Ron Burke and owner The OK Corral. As the 1-20 favorite, Drama Act paid \$2.10 to win and was atop a \$6.10 exacta and a \$24.20 trifecta. This was Drama Act's 34th career win, and she has now earned \$892,172.

Dougs Babe A became the first mare to upend Amazing Dream N in a thrilling finish, getting her nose in front in a 1:53.2 clocking for driver Dexter Dunn. The 6-year-old daughter of Western Terror won for the second straight week in the series for trainer Nifty Norman.



Majorca N and Dougs Babe A both left with purpose outside the rail-sitting favorite Amazing Dream N and driver Yannick Gingras. Corey Callahan had Majorca N claim the front from the favorite on the opening bend and then was under immediate attack from Dunn and Dougs Babe A. Gingras had Amazing Dream N out before the quarter and attacked Dougs Babe A to claim the top past the :27.2 opening quarter.

Gingras was able to get a healthy breather, hitting the half in :57.3 before Incaseyoudidnknow and Andrew McCarthy started their first-over grind. A 1:25.3 three-quarters kept Amazing Dream N in complete control, and the Linda Toscano-trained mare started her sprint on the final turn, leaving the outer flank out of contention. In the homestretch Dougs Babe A kicked out of the pocket and charged sharply to get up on the wire. Amazing Dream N fought bravely but lost a close photo, with Incaseyoudidnknow holding resolutely for third.

Owned by Vassiliou, Tallarico, Patricia Stable and Enzed Racing, Dougs Babe A likely assured herself a spot in the final with the win and returned \$8.20 to win. Dougs Babe A made her 13th appearance in the winner's circle, has now pocketed \$193,026, and keyed a \$14.20 exacta and a \$28.40 trifecta.

Lit De Rose and driver/trainer Patrick Lachance rallied boldly to get up in the final stride in the first of the three divisions. The 8-year-old by Leader Bayama overtook Karma Seelster in the final strides in a 1:52.4 mile to claim her first win in the series following three on-the-board finishes.

Mabalene N and driver Jason Bartlett blasted to the front over 6-5 favorite Gotthegreenlight into the first turn and cut opening-half fractions of :27.4 and :57 under little duress. Approaching the three-quarters, Matt Kakaley pulled Karma Seelster from third to attack, with Lachance and Lit De Rose moving to the outside but advancing slowly off cover. Mabalene N hit three-quarters in 1:24.3, but was under intense pressure on the final turn with Karma Seelster wresting command into the homestretch. Lachance set Lit De Rose in motion, and the

veteran mare kicked home for the victory. Karma Seelster held for second with Mabalene N third. Favored Gotthegreenlight found room to the inside in mid-stretch but failed to respond to urging.

Owned by Guy Corbeil, Lit De Rose was a winner for the second time in 11 starts in 2023 and returned \$4.80 as the second favorite in the field. The exacta was worth \$23.80 and the trifecta kicked back \$65.00. Lit De Rose is a 37-time winner in her life, and her bankroll stands at \$638,425.

Preliminary round action in the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series will wrap up next Friday (April 14) before a \$125,000 added final that should go for at least \$250,000 on April 24. The final of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series and companion consolation races for both events will also occur that night.

Stakes action will resume on Monday night (April 10) at MGM Yonkers Raceway with three \$50,000 splits of the third leg of the MGM Borgata Series for free-for-all pacers. Trotters will also be in action next week as the John Brennan Series continues with five \$25,000 sections of the second round on Wednesday (April 12).

To complement the MGM Borgata Pacing Series, the Empire Terrace dining room will be open 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. on Mondays through April 24. Owners and fans are invited to attend the races and enjoy food from an ala carte menu. No reservations are required.

Also, continuing through April, the Pick 5 pool on Thursdays at MGM Yonkers Raceway will be seeded with \$10,000 and also have a guaranteed pool of \$25,000. This initiative is being offered in partnership with the Standardbred Owners Association of New York as part of the United States Trotting Association's Strategic Wagering Program.

MGM Yonkers Raceway is currently operating on a Monday through Friday live racing schedule with post time at 7 p.m. (EDT).

Tetrick tallies four at Big M

The big man on campus Friday night (April 7) at The Meadowlands was Tim Tetrick, as the 41-year-old Hall of Fame driver recorded four victories on the 14-race card.

Tetrick was actually four out of 11 on the night, as three of the dashes were exclusively for members of the Meadowlands Amateur Drivers Club.

"The Bionic Man" registered his first win of the night behind **The Empress Ice**, who took the \$20,000 division of the second leg of the Standardbred Retirement Foundation series for 3-year-old fillies on the trot.

The Empress Ice stopped the clock in 1:55.3 to register her firstever win from seven career outings for trainer Nifty Norman, taking down heavy favorite Sheer Faith, who lost a second straight start as the 1-5 public choice.

"I really didn't want to leave with her," said Tetrick, who has now won nine races over the last three Big M cards. "But I was afraid if I didn't, the pace would be too slow [to come from off the pace]."

A daughter of Muscle Hill—The Ice Queen, The Empress Ice returned \$7.20 to her backers as the 5-2 second choice in the betting, winning by an easy 2 lengths. Sheer Faith settled for second for a second consecutive start.

The remainder of Tetrick's big night came with winner's circle visits guiding **Horoscope** (\$4.60 to win as the 6-5 favorite) in the seventh race; **Platinum As** (\$3.00 as the 1-2 public choice) in the 10th; and **Unstoppable Hall** (\$5.40 as the 8-5 second choice) in the 11th.

THAT GIRL IS SUPER: Super Girl (Downbytheseaside—Symphony In Motion) followed up a narrow head victory a week ago with a dominant 5½-length walk in the park in another \$20,000 SRF series dash, this one the second leg division for 3-year-old fillies on the pace.

The Mark Harder student was driven by Todd McCarthy to her third win in eight career starts in 1:51.1, in this, her first year on the track.

Super Girl returned \$3.00 as the 1-2 favorite.

THE STREAK LIVES: All-source wagering totaled \$3,070,369, keeping an impressive Big M betting streak alive.

There have been 26 Friday and Saturday night programs contested at The Meadowlands during 2023, and each one has seen betting bust the \$3-million barrier.

During 2022, there were a total of 85 race cards contested at the mile oval and betting went past the \$3-million plateau on 23 occasions.

A LITTLE MORE: Only three favorites hit victory lane on the program, serving as the catalyst for big payouts in the 20-cent Pick-5 (\$10,958.00), Early 50-cent Pick-4 (\$1,789.30), 20-cent Survivor Pick-7 (\$9,881.68) and 20-cent Pick-6 (\$2,954.86).


