Woodbine horses are coming to U.S. tracks at accelerated numbers

Meadowlands race secretary Scott Warren said Canadian horses are helping to fill fields, which is expected to drive handle.




Shutdown-impacted horses throughout Ontario have been migrating to the U.S. in increasing amounts over the last three weeks, and that number only continues to grow as confidence wanes for when racing will be allowed to resume across the Canadian province. As part of the latest extension of the Ontario lockdown, racing has been included in the ban of businesses not able to operate through at least until the currently scheduled date of May 20.

With horses needing to race and able to travel more freely and less subject to quarantine restrictions as people, an influx can be seen this weekend at American tracks. Hoosier Park and Northfield Park are each playing host to a dozen or so horses who have recently raced at Woodbine along with other tracks where Woodbine horses appear in smaller numbers, but it's the Meadowlands this weekend that's the highest recipient of horses recently raced at Woodbine.

By my math, there are 35 horses racing this weekend at the Meadowlands who had at least one race at Woodbine during March prior to the shutdown, and that's not even counting a

fresh batch that are qualifying at the Meadowlands Saturday.

The Meadowlands has historically been faced with the prospect of shorter fields this time of year as it faces competition from the recently-opened seasons of Philadelphia and Pocono from PA and Hoosier Park in Indiana, as well as consistent competition across the river at Yonkers. But that's not seen right now. This weekend, the Meadowlands has 26 races across Friday and Saturday and all of those except two races are full of either nine or 10-horse fields. That's not attributed entirely to horses coming in from Woodbine, but it's not hurting either.

No one in the industry wants to benefit by misfortune elsewhere, but the reality is that horses need to race and in the process it helps the tracks that can accommodate.

"It'll be helpful because we're all in competition for horses, and any horses that I can get helps," said Meadowlands race secretary Scott Warren. "I'm writing 3-year-old races that I started last week on the condition sheet and we had a couple of them fill this week. There's more 3-year-olds qualifying again this week, though the 3-year-old pacing colts I'll likely never see because they'll qualify this week and then go right into Pennsylvania as their first sire stake is next weekend."

Of the Canadian-based horses racing at the Meadowlands this weekend, the biggest name is Sintra who will now race for trainer Brett Pelling. The 8-year-old winner of more than \$1.1 million lifetime does have a history here, though has traditionally been campaigned by local connections in Ontario and enters the Meadowlands off back-to-back wins in the Woodbine preferred. In addition, on Saturday the 3-year-old gelding Control Heaven (Canadian stallion Control The Moment) was a Metro finalist last year and now debuts in his sophomore season for trainer Chris Ryder.

Many recently-arriving horses from Woodbine and other tracks such as Flamboro show recent enough lines so having to qualify first before racing hasn't been necessary. Warren said that standard qualifying rules at the Meadowlands would apply as dates become staler.

"The qualifying rule is a clean line within 45 days. So, if they choose to qualify with a clean line within 45 days they can do so on them."

Though more horses are arriving, Warren said he doesn't sense there will be such an overabundance that causes him to re-think conditions or think how to place them. But the addition of any horses, no matter the number, is contributing

to larger field sizes and in turn should drive handle.

"It definitely helps," said Warren of the full fields. "It hurt Saturday night when we had 10 scratches. I found out early in the afternoon and it put me in a bad mood for the rest of the day, but we still did \$3.6 million in handle that night. You've got to take advantage of the full fields when you can."

Warren said what's being seen consistently across the industry is tracks that are racing are picking up the handle where competition has decreased.

"I'll give you a specific example," he said. "Vernon Downs started up last week and we raced one day, Saturday. And we did \$192,000. That amount at Vernon is like a million-dollar night and that same night two years ago (they didn't race last year at this time due to the pandemic) we did \$54,000 in off-track money. A lot of smaller tracks are all seeing an increase in handle."

It's not only the horses who are on the move. Jody Jamieson has announced that he plans to drive at Tioga beginning in May while Doug McNair and Bob McClure are already at the Meadowlands.

"Doug is down to qualify Saturday and has multiple drives both Friday and Saturday," said Warren. McClure is coming down for Determination (Stables) and he's said that if he picks up extra work, he's happy to have it. To me, it's just going to make the driving colony even stronger and with the mix of a couple new drivers out there will make the racing even better."

Warren's correct in that the addition of new blood – both in the form of drivers and horses will help. Despite high handle, many races at the Meadowlands have become predictable and repetitive in horses up front not being challenged through the first half of the races. The new race participants may be able change the dynamic and mix things up a bit, which would further drive handle even more.

In the coming weeks it's expected that the number of horses coming from Ontario to the Meadowlands and other tracks will grow even more, and those numbers could potentially explode if the shutdown becomes extended once again. In the meanwhile, I'll be interesting to note how the horses adapt and if they adapt well, if they'll stay racing at the U.S. tracks indefinitely.









Jamieson worried about Ontario's horse racing community as he prepares to start driving at Tioga Downs

Driver Jody Jamieson said he's more fortunate than most in Ontario's horse racing community, but he's worried about what he sees from his colleagues rapidly fleeing the locked-down province to race their horses in the United States just to stay solvent.

"If they don't make a move here soon, they are going to be out of the business," said the three-time Canadian Driver of the Year (2007, 2009, 2011) and two-time World Driving Champion (2001 and 2011). "You can say that the horses are going to come back (to Ontario) and the horsepeople are going to come back when racing comes back (after the lockdown is over), and hopefully that's the case, but I don't think there's any guarantee that they are. People are having a really hard time feeding their horses now. This is the third lockdown inside a year and it's taken its toll on horses and horsepeople."

Jamieson said a telling sign is that many larger stables — such as Ben Baillargeon, Anthony MacDonald, Richard Moreau and Luc Blais — are shipping horses to the U.S.

"Those guys are the ones that made all the money last year and if they can't sit through another shut down for a month, six weeks, two months, what have you, how are the guys that didn't have a good go or just had an average year last year doing?"

On the driving front, many of the nation's top drivers have already left the province or will do so soon to race in the U.S. Trevor Henry and two-time Canadian Driver of the Year Louis-Philippe Roy (2018, 2019) are bound for Harrah's Hoosier Park in Indiana. Reigning Canadian Driver of the Year Bob McClure and 2017 Driver of the Year Doug McNair have landed at the Meadowlands and will drive at a number of

eastern tracks. Jamieson is headed for Tioga Downs for its May 1 season opener.

"For me, it's all based around time with my kids. I don't want to leave my kids for weeks at a time...Tioga kind of fit into my plans to do a little bit of work and be home through the week while the kids are doing home schooling," said Jamieson who arrived on Tioga as his destination something by accident.

"I was on the phone talking with a buddy of mine. He wanted to send his horses somewhere and we got looking around and talking about it and thought Tioga would be a good place to get young horses started before they come back to Ontario for the Sires Stakes, so that's where it all came from. He said, 'Would you be down there to drive them?' and I just thought about it for two seconds and then said, 'Why the hell not? Of course, I'll go down there and drive.' It's an easy decision to say yes, but coming back I'll have to quarantine unless I get an exemption."

In the meantime, Jamieson said the prevailing emotion in Ontario's horse racing community is anger.

"Obviously, the biggest frustration is that the government hasn't looked to horse racing and seen its perfect safety record with (COVID-19) in harness racing. People are mad that (Ontario premier Doug) Ford won't look at that,"

Jamieson said.

"You look at playgrounds being open or golf clubs being open and hockey being played and people are frustrated. I know (Ford) walked back closing the playgrounds, but not being able to play golf? That's silliness, so I can get behind that. I'm not even a big golfer, but I get behind that you're outside and how the hell is Coronavirus going to get you or how are you going to spread it outside? How many guys are in a hockey arena, side by side? It's entertainment and I love it. Thank God, we're allowed to watch hockey. I don't know what the hell we'd do if we weren't allowed to watch hockey, but the thing is, the cost to the industry from not being allowed to race while all these other things are being allowed to operate when we have a 100 per cent safety record... that really pissed people off.

"You get elected officials as well that aren't returning phone calls or emails, it just drives you crazy. You can't get any answers. It might not be the answer you want to hear, but just give us some information."

Despite a trying year and rising numbers of COVID-19 positives in Ontario, Jamieson said there have been some small blessings during the pandemic.

"I do feel like I live a normal life now. I'm home at night," he said. "It's different. I wouldn't call it nice, because I like being at the track and I like the idea of all day getting ready to prep and go to the track, but I've been noticing lately that I'm home. I live a normal life, like normal people do. They come home after work and they do their thing with their family and that's it. I just haven't done that for so long that I find it definitely different."

Beyond watching hockey, Jamieson said he has even started a new hobby with his new-found free time.

"I've actually taken up cooking... I've been watching cooking shows and cooking, not every night, but almost every night. I'm cooking for (my kids) and cooking healthy meals... When I was going to the track I wasn't going to be able to do anything like that. I never learned to cook, either, until the last little while and now I have a hankering for it and I really enjoy doing it."


Though, if given the chance, he'd trade his new hobby for a return to racing in a heartbeat.

Meadowlands task force members speak about improving the product

Horsepeople and gamblers also aim for better understanding between the groups.

A new panel has been formed, and it's going to take The Meadowlands to task.

"The committee was actually Mr. [Jeff] Gural's idea," said Meadowlands chief operating officer and general manager, Jason Settlemoir. "Taking recommendations from our customers that pay the bills and then getting input from our industry participants — trainers, drivers that are on this committee — we're trying to make the product here at The Meadowlands even better than what it is now. And I think our product is pretty damn good and I think the wagering numbers have shown that."

Their initial meeting was last week via conference call to have a candid dialogue of perceived issues on the track, and since no one on the task force was named, the following opinions are from three gamblers and four horsepeople that all have either raced or wagered at The Meadowlands. To allow these individuals to speak candidly, they will not be named. G1 through G3 will represent the gamblers while H1 to H4 will refer to the horsepeople.



"Having seen that this task force even exists is a breath of fresh air for a gambler," said G1. "It's completely unexpected because, being completely blunt, most gamblers feel like they don't have a voice. Nobody cares. Nobody treats them like a customer and for the most part, they're looked at as degenerates. So, just the fact that a gambler or more than one has a voice into something as important as this is really uplifting for other bettors to see."

The task force watch The Big M races each weekend and send notes to committee chairman Settlemoir prior to their weekly Wednesday call.

Even though they discussed more topics, this column will just focus on: courtesy tucks, driving half-in, half-out, and drifting in the stretch, which were mentioned in last week's press release.

No one contacted for this column had an issue with courtesy tucks.

"They're not courtesy tucks by any means," said H2. "I want to beat everybody out there. If we let somebody in, we're doing it for a reason. We may want to follow them or we may want to get them out of the way."

It was suggested that the inaccurate name "courtesy tuck" is part of the problem and that "strategy tuck" would be more appropriate, because that's what they actually are.

"I think for most of the guys, if they're letting somebody tuck, it's for a strategic reason, like they want to follow them later on in the mile," said G2. "It's not like they're doing just blatantly weird things."

In regard to driving half-in, half-out, none of the horsepeople contacted like it.

"It stops and stalls the whole race in the outer flow," said H4. "If you're going to move your horse, move him and go. It's like everybody's afraid to leave their horse uncovered and they want to wait until the last possible minute to pull. It just clogs up the middle half of the race."

The gamblers definitely don't like half-in, half-out either.

"Harness racing has turned into a speed-favoring game anyway, so when they're half-in and half-out and nobody moves, it makes it kind of boring," said G1. "For anybody that's been around for a long time, we can remember racing in the '80s and '90s at The Meadowlands, and if you weren't out and on the move before the half, you could go from second to last pretty quick."

Everyone agreed that speed plays a large part in the movement or lack thereof.

"Horses can only go so fast for so long," said H1. "The

horses are so much faster now than they were then. Look at the times compared to what they were 20 or 25 years ago."

As a frame of reference, in the '80s the average time of The Meadowlands Pace was 1:52.4. In the '90s it was 1:50.3, from 2000-2009 it was 1:48.4, and from 2010 through 2019, 1:47.4.

"So much action in the first quarter is the reason we don't see too much action in the second three-eighths," said G3. "Once they get near the quarter you can pretty much tell what the movement is going to be for the next three-eighths of a mile."

Since today you have fewer lengths per race to close into there's just a lot less you can do.

"I understand that movement creates a little more excitement but with the new breed of horses and just the way the races flow, it's extremely difficult to have horses looping around each other at the tempo we're going," said H3.

The last item discussed was drifting in the lane.

"A gambler has never driven a horse and he doesn't know what the horse is doing when he's tired," said H2. "Maybe there ought to be a task force to educate the gamblers and let them know what goes on. These are animals, not robots, not machines, not race cars. Some horses when they get tired, they pace or trot better when you can let them drift, but if you try to restrict them, they're not going to."

It appears to be the unpredictable nature of the drifting that upsets the gamblers.

"The worst thing about it is the inconsistency," said G2. "Sometimes you might be behind a dead horse and five times out of six you'll get through, they'll drift out and let you up the rail, and sometimes it doesn't happen. It alters the result of the race. The horse [in the pocket] was in no way going to win unless the horse [on the lead] got completely out of its way to allow it."

To wrap up, the suggestions were to leave alone the "strategy tucks" and to have the judge's fine drivers who sit half-in, half-out.

In regard to drifting in the lane, there was some grey area since it was agreed that tiring horses have always drifted out.

"[At Woodbine Mohawk Park], it's an automatic \$200 fine for drifting off the pylons down the lane," said H3. "In Canada, it's very enforced. The problem is, tired horses always tend to drift out."

It is a violation of the driving rule in Ontario to "Allow a

horse to pass needlessly on the inside, or commit any other act that helps another horse to improve its position," thus making it a judgement call which everyone will not always agree with.

"If you have a horse that's coming home in 30 seconds at The Meadowlands and you're told if you come off the pylons that's an infraction, you're going to get run over," said H3. "The only reason it should be strictly enforced is when the guy who's going to win the race moves off the pylons and finishes second because he moved off the pylons."

The task force will meet through the end of May and Settlemoir is excited to hear what they come up with.

"At the end of the day, to me it's all about perception and how our customers feel about our product and say about our product that's important to me and the same thing with Mr. Gural," said Settlemoir. "We want the cleanest, from an integrity standpoint, and the best racing here at The Meadowlands like we've always had and we'll continue to work on the product to continue to make it better day in and day out."

Ashley Eldred now all in on standardbreds

"Growing up, I never saw myself being a trainer or doing anything with racehorses."

Whenever the contented pair rides off into the sunset, it's a picture-perfect moment and reminder that life is indeed good for Ashley Eldred.

It's always a welcome scene, a picturesque landscape that seems to stretch on farther than the eye can see.

For the woman in the saddle, it's a time to let her busy mind rest, a chance for a cherished respite from a busy

standardbred life.

"I really do let my mind go," said Eldred, who calls Burlington Flats, NY home. "What's funny about that is when I have a barn full of horses at home – my outriding horses, my broodmares, all of these great riding horses – I still turn to my retired standardbred, Ehi Guaglione."

"Ehi" comes from the Nigerian name for "Angel" and "Guaglione" comes from the Neapolitan name for "Boy," resulting in "Angel Boy."

"He is 17. We go out for miles and hours. There's a nice hill with a sunset view. We just go out together and unwind. It's very peaceful. I've had him on and off since he was a baby. He was claimed several times from me, and sold, but he always finds his way back to me. He's very meaningful because he was the first horse I ever owned and trained. He's got a home for life."

Eldred, it appears, has a career for life.

Or more aptly put, careers.

"I'm extremely happy that everything keeps me so busy. I don't like any down time. I currently train 12 racehorses, I have the under saddle [RUS] gig that I do, and I also outride Fridays and Saturdays at Freehold. In any spare time I have, I recently got into the broodmare business, and had my first

foal this year. So I'm looking to expand in that aspect. If I do get a free moment, I go and enjoy a nice horseback ride. My spare time, it's still horse-related."

That she has found her way into the racing realm is somewhat of a longshot.

Growing up, she didn't give any thought of one day becoming involved in the standardbred industry.

Eventually, that mindset changed.

"I never wanted to do any of this. Growing up, I never saw myself being a trainer or doing anything with racehorses. My stepfather, Bill Bailey, who raised me, he was a very successful trainer and driver, as was his father [Jack]. I went to school, took some time off, and lived my life for a little bit. Somehow, I made my way to the racetrack, and over the past two or three years, I've really had the chance to take off in my training career. It's been very rewarding. This past year, I took my first open pace win, as well as getting my first Pocono Downs win. I had an amazing year in 2020 and I just hope to do better this year."

Launching her training career in 2015, Eldred and her band of trotters and pacers all hit their best stride last year, a season which produced 12 wins, 17 seconds and 15 thirds from 118 starts.

She's well on her way to eclipsing those numbers in 2021.

A recent rash of outside draws made for some tough results, but good fortune and better posts have yielded happier moments at the racetrack these days.

"Things have turned around as of late, which has been nice. Even in tough times, I never forget how lucky I am. I have some great people behind me, some great support, and I can't thank my team enough."

One member of her team goes by the name Paco, a 22-year-old horse that Eldred partners with for her outrider duties.

The role, and her on-track teammate, have both been an ideal match for the young horsewoman.

"I've always admired the outriders when I was growing up. I had never taken a lesson a day in my life. I taught myself everything I know, and with the help of so many people, I accepted my first full-time job last year, at Freehold. I've also filled in the odd time at Vernon Downs. I don't think it's going to take over my training job, but I really enjoy it."

It's anything but an easy role. A sharp mind and the ability to make split-second decisions are a necessity.

"The toughest part is in knowing when and how to do the right thing, putting yourself and your horse in the right position without getting hurt or hurting someone else. The most rewarding part is that the drivers look to you to help them. They rely on you. It's a big role, but it is rewarding. They know they can trust me to do my job and look after them."

Having Paco along for the ride makes it that much more gratifying for Eldred.

"I enjoy it and I have the best horse. He's been the greatest horse. He's helped me learn how to do my job out there and in rough situations, he's always taken care of me, on and off the track. He's really been a blessing."

Eldred applies the same sentiment to all of her horse racing positions.

Don't expect her to be riding off into the sunset soon, at least not at the racetrack.

"I don't think I could dream of anything better when it comes to my work. I don't think many people my age can say they love what they do. And if I don't like what I'm doing, I'm going to change it so that I am happy."







Youth will be served

Jesse Yoder's double-gaited world record at the age of 22 is just one of many incredible accomplishments by young drivers.

Who on earth sets a world record at age 22 — and as a provisional driver no less? Jesse Yoder did so at Harrah's Hoosier Park in March with Joe Joe Joe in a 1:54.4 trotting mile, giving him the new double-gaited standard of 3:45.1 since Joe Joe Joe owned a 1:50.2 mark pacing.

This brought back some memories. Let's take a look drivers younger than 25 who stepped up their game while their careers were just getting going:

Susan Looney was 16 in 1984 when she won at the Meadowlands with One For All. JoAnn King's daughter is the youngest to ever win a race at the Meadowlands, and that is not likely to change with the rule changing shortly after prohibiting 16-year-olds from driving there.

Kevin Lare, at age 17, is the youngest male driver to win at the Meadowlands. He was also winning opens across the river at Yonkers at age 18.

Doug McNair was 18 when he won the Battle of Waterloo for \$300,000 in 2008 with Trail Boss.

Walter "Butch" Paisley was 18 when he drove in the 1959 Hambletonian making him the youngest driver then and now to ever drive in that race. He finished 12-15 with Algiers Eblis.

Erik Adeilsson was 20 in 1995 when he finished seventh with Easy Lover in the Hambletonian at the Meadowlands. He is the youngest driver to try it in since the Hambletonian moved to New Jersey.

Ryan Anderson was 20 when he won the Breeders Crown of 2000 (3YOFP).

Peter Haughton was 20 years in November of 1974 when he set the world race record for females of 1:54.4 with Handle With Care taking a \$50,000 test at Hollywood Park versus the males, including the defending Horse of the Year Sir Dalrae.

Ron Pierce was 21 when he won his first two Meadowlands races in July 1977. He then took a decade or so before making his way back to East Rutherford.

Richie Silverman was second in the 1985 Woodrow Wilson the year he turned 21.

Andrew McCarthy was 22 when he drove Muscle Hill in a qualifier and to victory in a division of the Simpson.

Haughton won the Kentucky Futurity at 22 with Quick Pay, making Haughton the youngest to ever win a Triple Crown event.

Jimmy Takter was just 22 when, while working for Nordin Stable, he won his first Meadowlands race driving Baltic Speed in a New Jersey Sires Stakes event in 1983.

Tommy Haughton was 23 when he was the regular driver for Final Score the 3YOCT of the year in 1980 and the Hambletonian runner-up.

Scott Zeron was and is the youngest driver ever to win a Triple Crown pacing event — 2013 with Michaels Power in the Jug. Zeron was 23, two years younger than the winning sire, Camluck.

John Campbell was 24 in 1979 when he led the nation in earnings with \$3,308,984. It was the first of his 16 titles.

Montrell Teague was 24 when Wiggle It Jiggleit dominated in 2015 for the sport's last \$2 million single season and HOY honors.

Haughton dominance

In 1974, in all of standardbred racing, there were 17 races carrying a pure of \$100,000 or more and eight of those (47 per cent) were won by a driver named Haughton. Billy won five and Peter won three.

Billy won four with Armbro Omaha — the \$104,350 Adios, \$132,638 Little Brown Jug, the \$151,043 Messenger and the \$100,000 L K Shapiro. His other six-figure win came in the \$160,150 Hambletonian with Christopher T.

Peter's three came with Keystone Smartie in the \$113,350 American Classic and Armbro Omaha in both the \$117,095 Keystone Gabriel and the \$150,00 Prix D'Ete.

The nine other six-figure races were won by nine other drivers:

\$200,000 Roosevelt International won by John Chapman with Delmonica Hanover

\$125,821 Yonkers Trot won by Delvin Miller with Spitfire Hanover

\$109,550 American Classic won by Jim Dennis with Savoir

\$101,598 American National Maturity won by Herve Filion with Otaro Hanover

\$121,822 Cane Futurity won by William Herman with Boyden Hanover

\$112,380 Dexter Cup won by William Wellwood with Surge Hanover

\$100,000 Fox Stake won by Glen Garnsey with Alert Bret

\$100,000 Kentucky Futurity won by John Simpson, Jr. with Waymaker

\$141,562 Realization won by George Sholty with Wayne Eden

It's unofficial, but can anyone document whether or not any track has ever been able to say the following?

Harrah's Hoosier Park in the first two weeks of April — and not even with a full schedule, yet — had three different drivers that had five baggers:

John DeLong - 5

Sam Widger - 6

Trace Tetrick – 7, twice

Do Horses of the Year race in April?

Some did, but not a lot. Here's a look at some names and those who gave it a go in the fourth month of the year:

2019 — Shartin N won the Matchmaker in April the year she took down year-end honors.

2015 — Wiggle It Jiggleit was active from early on in his standout HOY season.

2011 — San Pail won the Glorys Comet in Canada in January, rested a bit and qualifed back a couple of times in April.

2004 - Rainbow Blue got her HOY season in 2004 off and

with a bang with a sweep of the Blossom Series. This came after three qualifiers in March, two at Dover and one at the Meadowlands. Her incredible season saw her go 20-for-21.

1995 — C R Kay Suzie had a lone prep at Spring Garden Ranch in 1995 in April, then dominated her division from there.

2001 — Bunny Lake had three qualifiers between Saratoga and the Meadowlands in 2001. She would win her final 19 starts to cement HOY honors over undefeated Syrinx Hanover (12-for-12) and a couple of tough hombres named Real Desire and Bettors Delight.

1993 — Staying Together was an iron horse. The year after Bob McIntosh went undefeated with HOY Artsplace, the trainer came right back with Staying Together who was 3-4 in races in April after getting his season underway in March.

1991 — Precious Bunny. He would set a new earnings record, but his first three starts all came in conditioned tests for less than \$10,000.

1990 — Beach Towel, the year he topped \$2 million for a single season, started at Rosecroft in April in a pair of preps there and one open.

1989 — Matts Scooter had a pair of wins and a second starting in the Graduate, the Levy and the Cornell at Freehold.

1986 — Forrest Skipper went unblemished in 1986 and had a couple of early scores came in April, the Graduate twice and the Cornell at Freehold.

1983 — Cam Fella had five April starts at four different tracks — three wins and two seconds.

1982 — Cam Fella started three times in April at Los Alamitos in the Spring Championship Series, taking two prelims but finishing 7th in the \$300,000 final.

Yannick Gingras blasted This Is The Plan off the gate from post eight to win the \$514,000 final of the Borgata Pacing Series on Monday at Yonkers.

Post eight proves no obstacle to This Is The Plan in MGM Borgata Pacing Series final

This Is The Plan was able to overcome starting from the outside post eight with a blitz off the gate and then never let anybody get close to him after that in winning Monday night's (April 19) \$514,000 MGM Borgata Pacing Series final at Yonkers Raceway in 1:50.4. This Is The Plan, driven by Yannick Gingras and one of three in the final sent out by trainer Ron Burke, was dispatched at odds of 11-1.

Rockapelo (George Brennan), Hesa Kingslayer N (Jim Marohn Jr.), Mach N Cheese (Joe Bongiorno), Western Joe (Dexter Dunn), Backstreet Shadow (Tim Tetrick), and This Is The Plan all showed speed at the start of the race, but it was This Is The Plan who was able to go from six-wide early on the bend to leading over stablemate Rockapelo by the time they entered the backstretch for the first time. Everybody else then got down to the cones except for Backstreet Shadow, who was left on the outside as the first quarter rang up in :26.4.

On the second turn, 6-5 favorite Western Joe, who had landed in fourth, flushed Hesa Kingslayer N out of third, and they made some progress towards This Is The Plan at the :55.1 half, but then the pace dramatically quickened past that marker as Gingras stepped on the accelerator and This Is The Plan responded by opening up a gap on the rest of the field in a third quarter that went on the board in 27 seconds flat.

After building up that advantage on his pursuers, This Is The Plan was not about to relinquish it, as he paced home in :28.3 to seal the deal by a length and a half over Rockapelo, who went off at 13-1. Mach N Cheese saved ground on the inside and finished third at 32-1, and 26-1 offering Lyons Steel (Corey Callahan) also stayed on the pylons and wound up fourth. Leonidas A, the 5-2 second choice, got away last from post seven, could never get involved, and had to settle for fifth.

"That was the plan for sure, at least Plan A. I wasn't going to sit eighth. Maybe I was going to be parked the whole mile, but I was going to leave as hard as I could. The horse has great gate speed, and I thought I had the best horse, so I had to get him into the race somehow," said Gingras. "I was four-wide for a ways there, and I was just telling Ronnie (Burke), 'the plan became catch me if you can at the half.' I knew the backfield would be coming, but I figured I'd just take off and make them try to catch me."

A 6-year-old gelding by Somebeachsomewhere, This Is The Plan is owned by Burke Racing Stable LLC., Weaver Bruscemi LLC., J&T Silva- Purnel & Libby, and Larry Karr. This Is The Plan is now a 16-time winner in his career, and the winner's share of the purse made him harness racing's newest double millionaire, as his lifetime earnings now stand at \$2,073,700. This Is The Plan paid \$24.40 to win and was atop a \$240.50 exacta and a \$2,020 trifecta.

"When they came out with the nominations for the series, I thought 'this is the best horse.' He's got \$2 million made. He's a true free-for-aller," said Burke. "Even before the race, I was like, 'I think he can make the top from the eight-hole,' and [co-owner] Mark (Weaver) was like, 'Do you think he can clear from there?' and I was like, 'I think he can clear from there.' The only thing that almost stopped him was Backstreet (Shadow) having a leg underneath him when he hit the turn. When you come away with first and second out of that, it's a lot of money."

Western Fame (Dan Dube), who won the MGM Borgata Pacing Series final the last time it was held in 2019, was victorious in Monday's \$100,000 consolation event. He pulled out of the pocket going to the 1:22.4 three-quarters, wore down leader San Domino A (Todd McCarthy) and prevailed by two lengths in 1:51.2. Mac's Jackpot (Tim Tetrick) was the runner-up from second-over, and Raukapuka Ruler N (Jordan Stratton) got up for third.

Purchased in an online auction earlier this month, Western Fame, an 8-year-old Western Ideal stallion, scored in his second start for trainer Daniel Renaud and owner Dune Road Stables LLC. Western Fame is now a 30-time winner in his career, and he has banked \$1,882,775. Western Fame returned \$4.80 to win as the favorite and keyed a \$33.60 exacta and a \$260.00 trifecta.

Monday night's card at Yonkers Raceway drew plenty of attention on the wagering front from start to finish, as the handle on the 10-race program went into seven-figure territory, ending at \$1,121,424.

Machnhope tenacious from first-over in Blue Chip Matchmaker Series final

The betting was focused on two mares in Monday's (April 19) \$232,800 Blue Chip Matchmaker Series final at Yonkers Raceway, but in the end it would be 6-1 shot **Machnhope** that would get the job done in game fashion, overtaking Blue Ivy near the wire to score in 1:52.2 for driver Andrew McCarthy.

The action was hot and heavy at the outset as four horses left the gate, including favored Alexa Skye from post six, but the even-money choice would have to be content with a tuck in the four-hole as George Brennan, behind Snobbytown, circled Blue Ivy on the first turn and drove past Machnhope to take charge. Tyler Buter, driving 3-2 second choice Blue Ivy, may have been outsprinted early, but the two quickly seized control well before the :27.1 opening quarter. From there, Buter and Blue Ivy kept the pace somewhat lively, hitting the half in :55.3 before feeling any heat.

Todd McCarthy and Alexa Skye got off the pylons at the half and quickly flushed Machnhope's cover. What looked like a perfect trip for the favorite at that juncture didn't turn out that way, though, as while Machnhope moved towards the pace-setter, Alexa Skye stalled and couldn't stay on her cover.

With Blue Ivy still in control at three-quarters in 1:23.4, the

second choice looked in position to win, but Machnhope, under steady urging by Andrew McCarthy, kept grinding her way towards the leader. The field got a bit crowded in deep stretch as Snobbytown searched for room but was unable to find any. Machnhope showed her tenacity near the wire, securing the victory for trainer Noel Daley, who shares ownership in the 6-year-old daughter of Mach Three with Deo Volente Farms LLC., Tom Pontone, and L A Express Stable LLC. Snobbytown settled for third behind Blue Ivy, with Alexa Skye holding fourth on the line.

"Everything went right out there," said Daley. "She was sound, with no issues, and Andy really knows how to drive her. She just got there on her own."

It was the fourth win in 11 tries this year for Machnhope and her 30th career victory. She also pushed her 2021 earnings to \$184,115 and her lifetime bankroll to \$521,394. Machnhope returned an even \$14 to win, with the exacta returning \$53.50 and the triple \$223.50.

Soho Burning Love A, half of the Jim King Jr.-trained entry that was sent off at odds of 1-5, was a dominant force in the \$60,000 Blue Chip Matchmaker consolation, distancing herself from the field on the final turn and scoring powerfully in 1:51.4 for driver Tim Tetrick.

Soho Burning Love A took control on the first turn and set a sensible early pace, hitting the quarter in :27.4 and half in :56.2, with entrymate Keep Rockin A (Andrew McCarthy) in pocket position. Tetrick allowed Soho Burning Love A to turn on the afterburners on the third turn, and the 7-year-old blew out a :27.2 third quarter, losing the majority of the field in the process. In the homestretch Soho Burning Love A sealed the win with a 28-second final quarter, as Bettors Heart N (Dexter Dunn) rallied late to be a distant second ahead of Parisian Blue Chip (Dan Dube).

Owned by Richard Poillucci and Jo Ann Looney-King, Soho Burning Love A returned \$2.50 as the prohibitive choice, keying a \$8.90 exacta and \$23.20 triple.

John Brennan Trotting Series final goes to Get Legs

Get Legs rallied after working out a second-over trip and got up through the lane to win the \$69,000 final of the John Brennan Trotting Series on Wednesday night (April 21) at Yonkers Raceway as the 1-9 favorite.

Starting from post six, Get Legs (Andy Miller) didn't have the quickest of beginnings, landing in sixth, but he was able to improve one spot to fifth as Look In My Eyes (Jordan Stratton) miscued on the opening turn. Meanwhile, Lady Jeter (Yannick Gingras) did have a fast start, as she blasted out from post six and established command well before the :28.4 opening quarter.

Guilty Desire (Nick Clegg), who made a brief break just prior to the start, was able to get back on-stride quickly and then began a first-over move out of fourth on the second turn, giving Get Legs cover. Guilty Desire advanced into second as Lady Jeter tripped the half-mile point at :59.3, and remained in that position to the 1:28.4 three-quarters as Lady Jeter continued on the front-end and gave her two-wide challenger the cold shoulder.

On the far turn, Gingras asked Lady Jeter to accelerate as Get Legs tipped out three-wide, and Lady Jeter responded as she had a couple of lengths on Get Legs turning into the lane. It was not enough, though, as despite drifting out, Get Legs was hand-driven home by Miller and surged by Lady Jeter en route to a 1 3/4 length decision in 1:58.3. Tad Krazy Hanover (Scott Zeron) was third, followed by Guilty Desire and Windsong Pioneer (Brent Holland).

Trained by Julie Miller, Get Legs is a 4-year-old son of Muscle Hill owned by Andy Miller Stable and Michael Anderson. Get Legs has compiled a record of 11-0-2 from 13 starts, and he has now pocketed \$120,510. He returned \$2.10 to win, place, and show and was atop a \$15.00 exacta and a \$94.50 trifecta.

In the \$30,000 consolation event of the series, **Halo Its Me** (Gingras) sailed to the lead from post seven and reached the opening quarter in 28.2 before yielding to Stinglike A B K (Tyler Buter). Stinglike A B K then made a break prior to the 58.4 half, leaving Halo Its Me back on the point as Blue And Bold (Holland) briefly vacated the cones to go first-over before he went back to the inside on the third turn.

Halo Its Me got some separation on the others going towards three-quarters, which she posted in 1:28, but 3-2 favorite Hunting AS (Todd McCarthy) was making steady progress after tipping out first-up once Blue And Bold elected to drop back down to the pylons and joined Halo Its Me on the last turn. Hunting AS was able to forge his way into the lead in the stretch and then held off a determined bid by Bazillionaire (George Brennan), who surged from second-over, to win by a nose in 1:59.2. Blue And Bold wound up third.

Hunting AS is a 4-year-old Lionhunter gelding trained by Jenny Melander for owners Melander Racing Inc., Clark



Stables LLC., and Robert Bernaski. Hunting AS picked up his seventh career win, and he has now earned \$96,956. Hunting AS paid \$5.00 to win and led a \$116.50 exacta and a \$452.00 trifecta.

Stakes racing at Yonkers Raceway will resume on Friday, May 7 when the track plays host to the Reynolds Stakes, a Grand Circuit event for 3-year-old pacers of both sexes.

Award winners lead Hambletonian, Hambletonian Oaks eligible

Award winners On A Streak and Venerate lead a group of 82 colts and geldings eligible to August's Hambletonian Stakes, harness racing's premier race for 3-year-old trotters, at the Meadowlands Racetrack in East Rutherford, NJ.

The Hambletonian Oaks, the event's filly-restricted companion race, attracted 90 eligibles, with award recipients Anoka Hanover and Donna Soprano at the top of the list.

Fillies have the option of competing in the Hambletonian rather than the Oaks. A filly has won two of the three most recent editions of the Hambletonian, with Ramona Hill accomplishing the feat last year and Atlanta in 2018. A total of 15 fillies have won the Hambletonian, which began in 1926.

The \$1 million final of the 96th Hambletonian and \$500,000 final of the 51st Hambletonian Oaks will be Aug. 7 at the Meadowlands. Eliminations for each race, if necessary, will be July 31.

Venerate was last season's top earner among 2-year-old trotters, banking \$772,914, and received the Dan Patch Award for best

2-year-old male trotter. Venerate had five wins and three thirds in 10 starts, with his victories including the inaugural Mohawk Million and the Kentucky Sire Stakes championship.

Julie Miller trains Venerate, by Love You out of Peaceful Kemp, for owners Pinske Stables and Andy Miller Stable. Venerate is ranked No. 1 in Meadowlands announcer/analyst Ken Warkentin's Hambletonian winter book Top 10.

"I really think toward the end of last year he showed a lot of maturity," Julie Miller said. "To do what he did, with the travel, I think he really developed a professional attitude. He handled every circumstance pretty well.

"I'm looking forward to getting him ready. Hopefully, he decides to really sparkle that first week in August. He's full of himself. He knows that he's special, that's for sure. He's definitely got that personality."

On A Streak was the O'Brien Award winner in Canada for best 2-year-old male trotter. His wins included the Breeders Crown and William Wellwood Memorial and he ranked second to Venerate in earnings, with \$740,947. Luc Blais trains On A Streak, by Cantab Hall out of Habit's Best, for owner Determination.

"I'm very happy with how he has come back," Blais said.
"He's a very laidback horse, not tough on himself, and I think that's his best quality."

Venerate (Andy Miller, winning in Kentucky in 2020) is an early Hambletonian favorite.

Determination and Blais also team up with Hambletonian Oaks eligible Donna Soprano. A daughter of Donato Hanover out of Windsong Soprano, she was the O'Brien Award winner for best 2-year-old filly trotter and counted the Peaceful Way among her five wins last season. She challenged the boys in the Mohawk Million, finishing second to Venerate.

"She is feeling good," Blais said. "She's a special character, but she's got a lot of speed and talent."

Blais and Determination, who also have Grand Circuit winning colt Macho Martini among their Hambletonian hopefuls, won the 2019 Hambletonian with Forbidden Trade.

Dan Patch Award winner Anoka Hanover was last season's richest 2-year-old filly trotter, with \$587,758 in purses, and the fastest, with a mark of 1:52.3. Her 10-win campaign included a seven-race win streak to end the season and her multiple triumphs on the Grand Circuit included the Goldsmith Maid.

Noel Daley trains Anoka Hanover, a daughter of Donato Hanover out of Aunt Mel, and shares ownership with Caviart Farms, Crawford Farms Racing, and L.A. Express Stable.

"She looks good and I'm very happy with her demeanor," said Daley, who won the 2011 Hambletonian with Broad Bahn. "She's got a good attitude, which is always good. She wasn't perfect gaited last year, but she knew how to win. The fact she ended last year on such a good note gives me confidence she will come back good."

Among the remaining colts and geldings eligible to the Hambletonian is Southwind Tyrion, who won in 1:51.1 last year to become history's fastest 2-year-old male trotter. He is trained by Ake Svanstedt, who won the 2017 Hambletonian by disqualification with Perfect Spirit.

"Southwind Tyrion is a real racehorse," Svanstedt said. "He has the whole package. He has a big heart, the speed, and he is a strong horse."

Svanstedt's stable also includes Hambletonian-eligible colts Captain Corey and Delayed Hanover, who both were winners on the Grand Circuit last year.

Other Grand Circuit winning males eligible to the

Hambletonian include: Peter Haughton Memorial champ Zenith Stride, Valley Victory winner Bee Forever, and Matron Stakes winner Type A, as well as Arnold N Dicky, Cuatro De Julio, Dancinginthedark M, Lucky Rascal, and Take All Comers.

Other Grand Circuit winning fillies eligible to the Hambletonian Oaks include: Breeders Crown champion Lady Chaos, Jim Doherty Memorial winner Darlene Hanover, and Matron Stakes winner Illuminata, as well as Beautiful Game, Dicentra, Flawless Country, Hello I Love You, Insta Glam, Iteration, Presto, Pub Crawl, and Shirley Goodness.

The Hambletonian is the second leg in this year's Trotting Triple Crown, following the Yonkers Trot on July 2 and preceding the Kentucky Futurity on Oct. 10.

This season's first Grand Circuit event for 3-year-old trotters is the Dexter Cup. Eliminations, if necessary, will be Saturday (April 24) at Freehold Raceway with the final on May 1. Entries for the Dexter Cup close 9 a.m. (EDT) Wednesday.

One Eight Hundred aims to be No. 1 in Weiss

After winning starts in two preliminary rounds of the Bobby Weiss Series for 3-year-old male pacers, One Eight Hundred will attempt to close out the event with a victory in Saturday's (April 24) \$40,000 final at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

Purchased at the 2019 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale under the name Some Terror for \$800,000 — the auction record for a yearling pacer — the colt won one of five races at age 2 before being shut down by trainer Nancy Takter and given time to mature.

He returned this season and won his debut by 6-3/4 lengths in 1:50.2, with a :26.1 last quarter-mile, in the opening round of the Weiss on April 3. He sat out the second leg, then won gate-to-wire in last week's third round by 2-1/2 lengths in 1:52. In that start, he paced the first quarter in :26.2 before settling into a :58.2 middle half and kicking home in :27.1 over a track labeled "good."

"I think he's handled those two miles very well," driver Josert Fonseca said. "He surprised me — I think he probably surprised everybody — how good he did it. He showed a lot of maturity to open up in 26-and-a-piece and be able to back off and be cool with it. I was really happy to see that.

"Maturity wise, he's gotten a lot smarter. He knows what he's doing. He's so versatile now, you can leave with him or you can back him down and he's okay either way. I think that's what I like most about him from last year to this year."

One Eight Hundred, a son of Somebeachsomewhere out of Dan Patch Award winner Economy Terror, is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in the Weiss final. He will start from post six with Fonseca in the sulky. The colt is owned by Brixton Medical Inc. and Takter.

Fonseca's rapport with One Eight Hundred calls to mind his work with pacer No Lou Zing last year. Fonseca, Takter's

second trainer, drove No Lou Zing in the first six starts of his 3-year-old campaign before turning the horse over to driver Dexter Dunn. No Lou Zing, winless in three starts at 2, last season was a winner on the Grand Circuit and Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion, banking \$523,558.

"Really, it's almost like that," Fonseca said. "Nancy had me qualify (One Eight Hundred) and told me to just do the same thing I did with No Lou Zing. She wanted him to finish strong and learn how to race and not get too worked up. That's what we tried to do. So far, he's been respecting everything we've asked of him.

"Nancy has done a really good job managing him; there was no rush with him. We knew he had ability and potential, so they took their time with him. He's a big horse and he just needed time. So far so good. It looks like it's been working the right way."

Straight Talk, also 2-for-2 in the Weiss series, is the 3-1 second choice in the final. He is trained by Ron Burke and will have Matt Kakaley at the lines, leaving from post seven. McNair to drive at Harrah's Philly, other eastern tracks

With racing in Ontario on hold for the foreseeable future due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a number of top stables and drivers have made the decision to venture to the United States to compete in preparation for the upcoming stakes season. One such driver, Doug McNair, is hoping to make an impact at Harrah's Philadelphia, where he will begin driving today (April 23).

McNair, who has won over 3,600 races in his career, has stamped himself as one of Canada's best, having won the 2017 O'Brien Award as Canada's Driver of the Year and the Canadian National Driving Championship in 2018. While the 31-year-old Ontario native has conquered just about every challenge he has faced north of the border, he relishes the chance to compete against the best of the best in the States, too.

"I want to drive with the best there are to drive with, and that's where the best are, all on the East Coast," McNair said. "I just hope I can fit in with them. They know the horses' tendencies more than anybody, and you can get a better grip on how the races are going to go."

McNair, who will make his temporary home in southern New Jersey, is listed in four races on Friday's card, and he threatens to contend with his first two: Josh Green trainee Betsea, who is the 3-1 second choice in the fourth race, an \$8,800 mid-level conditioned pace for fillies and mares; and Jim Rocks, a Blake MacIntosh trainee whom McNair drove in his first qualifier last June at Woodbine Mohawk Park, in the sixth race, a \$9,600 maiden pace. Four drives on a 14-race

card may seem like a light work load, but McNair understands it will take time for him to gain momentum — and favor — within the local pool of horsemen:

"You've got to put your work in, pick up as much work as you can, and hopefully after a couple weeks, get on the better horses and make a little money," he said.

In addition to Harrah's Philadelphia, McNair will drive at The Downs At Mohegan Sun Pocono, Yonkers Raceway, and The Meadowlands, where he is listed on seven horses Friday night and another two Saturday (April 24).

"I'm just trying to stay busy, that's all. It doesn't look like we'll be opening up for four to six weeks, so I'll probably try to stay down there as long as I can until the stakes start back up (in Canada) — they could be a couple months, yet," he said.

Yet, while McNair doesn't plan on any idle time in his southern sojourn, he's most excited about the opportunity to take on, arguably, the sport's toughest driving colony at the riverside racetrack in Chester, PA four afternoons a week — and make an already star-studded lineup of reinsmen all the stronger.

"There's a lot of races and a lot of full fields. It's the place to be, I think."

Pastor Stephen has been very successful in the breeding shed all across Europe with a more than 70 per cent rate of his foals making it to the races, all despite the fact that he was held up in a court case and lost two full breeding seasons.

"The horse is proving himself in Europe," Miller said. "They are racing very well over there and this year he has had a great season there as a stallion. I get calls almost daily from Filip Van Hauwermeiren in Europe telling me about this horse and that horse, all by Pastor Stephen, who are doing well at the races.

"He is throwing nice big strong horses and that 7/8th mile track at Hoosier Park, will be just perfect for his foals.

"He has his work cut out for him this year," Miller said about Pastor Stephen's stallion duties. "From August to January we were freezing his semen to send over to Europe. Then he breeds at Premier Acres now until July and then he heads down under where I think he will be quite popular."

Pastor Stephen will later this year board a plane bound for Northern Rivers Equine at Kyabram, Victoria in Australia to commence his first breeding season in the flesh Down Under.

Trotting filly Bella Bellini in season's record 1:54 in sophomore bow

The maiden Bar Hopping filly **Bella Bellini**, making her first start since Oct. 10, equaled the fastest clocking by any 3-year-old trotter in North America this year, 1:54, when she won her \$17,500 division of the final preliminary of her Bobby Weiss Series action Tuesday afternoon (April 20) at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

Living up to her pedigree (in addition to her sire, her dam is the \$700G+ winner Bella Dolce, she a daughter of champion and producer of three \$500G+ winners Pizza Dolce), Bella Bellini had the lead before the :28.3 quarter, backed the half off to :58, then sprinted to hit the three-quarters in 1:25.3 before drawing clear to win by 15¼ lengths for driver Dexter Dunn, trainer Nifty Norman, and owner David McDuffee, who has had a long involvement with this family.

The 1:54 clocking equals the figure put up by the gelding Winning Ticket over the 5/8-mile Miami Valley oval, and is superior to any time posted by a sophomore filly on any size of track.

That previous mark for fillies of 1:54.3 had been established 32 minutes earlier at Pocono by another Dunn/Norman/McDuffee horse, the Muscle Hill filly **Eazy Pass**. Owned by McDuffee in partnership with Melvin Hartman and Diamond Creek Racing, Eazy Pass also proved uncatchable on the lead, and was seven lengths clear at the finish to run her Weiss record to 2-for-2.

Prospects for a sweep for Dunn/Norman and a second win for Team Eazy Pass were dashed when Rebel Girl, a winner in her only previous Weiss outing, was scratched sick. Taking advantage was another daughter of Bar Hopping, Nancy Bar, who rode in the pocket then edged favored Lexa Hanover to break her maiden in 1:58 for driver Fern Paquet Jr., trainer Rob Harmon, and owner Tom Haughton.

Nifty Norman has three fillies undefeated in this section of the Weiss, but only the double winner Eazy Pass (the only double winner this section produced) garnered enough points to make the provisionary list of top point winners,

which reads: Alpine; Etra De Vie; Eazy Pass; Nancy Bar; P L Olivia; Lexa Hanover; Frankly My Dear and Trip Sevens (tie); and Orange Zest. Two horses, Kayla's Playmate and R Speed Of Light, will decide AE1 / AE2 by luck of the draw if needed. Bella Bellini and Rebel Girl are tied for 16th.

Incaseyoudidntknow impressive in third straight Weiss Series win

The Always B Miki filly **Incaseyoudidntknow** became the only sophomore pacing miss to win in all three of her Bobby Weiss preliminary action on Monday (April 19) at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, overcoming the outside post six, broken equipment, and a hard uncovered journey while taking a new mark of 1:52.2.

Away fourth for driver Marcus Miller in her \$17,500 section, Incaseyoudidntknow started on the limb midway between the :27 quarter and the :56.3 half, and she just kept gaining to and past the 1:23.4 three-quarters. With foes coming from every direction, Incaseyoudidntknow paced resolutely to the wire for a two length victory, with her own last half in :55.2 despite her hardships, and she remains undefeated in three 2021 starts and boosted her lifetime record to 7-for-8 for trainer Les Givens and the partnership of Jim Magno and Joe Fonte.

The So Surreal filly **Carrington** was third in her first prelim and second in her second, and she kept up the incremental improvement to win her Weiss section in 1:52.3, a career best clocking. Mark MacDonald left with Carrington from the rail and caused a "lineup," with the improving filly coming home in :55.1 – :27.2 to ensure her victory for trainer Ray Schnittker, co-owner with Ted Gewertz.

So Irresistible had a chance to join Incaseyoudidntknow as a Weiss prelim sweeper, but after setting the pace she was caught up the inside by 31-1 shot **Shes So Sweet** by a head in 1:53.2, a lifetime best. Matt Kakaley gave the daughter of Sweet Lou a perfect pocket trip and then helped her maximize her good fortune for hot trainer Eddie Dennis and owner Eric Good.

The point standings for eligibility for next Monday's \$40,000 Weiss Series Championship: Incaseyoudidntknow; So Irresistible; Carrington and Milieu Hanover (tie); Roll On Mama; Shes So Sweet; AP Blaze Of Glory; Baci Baci; and Beach Crazy. AE1 will be Atomic Fireball, and AE2 will be Indra Hanover.

In all, 11 horses posted lifetime quickest miles during Monday's fourteen races.

The draw was held Monday for this Saturday's \$40,000 Weiss Championship for 3-year-old pacing males, and highly-regarded One Eight Hundred drew post six in the field of nine. Interestingly, the other two-time prelim winners all drew outside him: Straight Talk (7), Coalition Hanover (8), and Mad Man Hill (9). There will also be two \$17,500 Weiss consolations.

The Southwind Frank colt **Pilot Hanover** a \$240,000 yearling, punched his ticket for the \$40,000 Championship next Sunday, but he needed the entire stretch to get ahead of a game Ceffyl Dwr by a nose while reducing his mark to 1:55.3. Mattias Melander was in charge of the consistent sophomore for trainer/brother Marcus Melander and S R F Stable.
