One Hec of a life

A conversation with horseman / politician / athlete Hector Clouthier

If one were to describe Hector Clouthier, one could use several descriptions and be right on course.

Is he a horseman? Indeed. He has been one for the vast majority of his life. Clouthier actually drove and won at The Meadowlands in 1980. In one winning photo, the drivers following him across the finish line were John Campbell, Ray Remmen, Buddy Gilmour and Benny Webster. Pretty good company.

Is he a politician? He has spent a good part of his career walking the halls of the Canadian Parliament as a member and as a "fixer" who was employed by one of his mentors, Prime Minister Jean Chretien to head the caucus, keep the troops in line and to aid in establishing public policy.

Is he an athlete? Indeed. He keeps running marathons and playing hockey at the age of 73.

Let's tackle them one by one.

You were involved in the sport for quite some time as a trainer and driver, however not on a full-time basis.

"You might say that. However, it was mostly as an avocation and not a lifetime job. During the time that I trained and drove my dad's [also Hector] horses, I was also involved in our family's lumber, hotel and farming business. In the lumber business, during my dad's era, he used a lot of heavy draft horses. A friend of dad's suggested that he take his interest in horses one step further and get involved in harness racing. Dad thought that it was a good idea and enlisted Keith Waples as his trainer. In harness racing, as in the lumber business, there are no substitutes for quality, so he got the best, Keith Waples, to become his trainer/driver. His first good horse was Barney Diplomat a pretty decent 'A' pacer in that day which he bought in 1951 from London hotel man Alex Parsons for the then significant price of \$10,000.

"I was one of 10 kids and the only son at that time who was keenly interested in harness racing. My sister Sandra, who is a much better horse person than me, was also interested but not as a driver and to this day trains young racehorses. Dad was not one to be a passive owner. He quickly got deeply involved in the business, not only in building his stable, but also in other facets of the game by breeding and raising his own horses.

"He was also one of the founders of the United Harness Horsemen's Association, one of the very first groups to advocate for the needs and purses of working horsemen. Back then, track management gave the horsemen purses that they might have felt were a fair expression of their needs. They were likely the only ones that believed that mantra. We were racing for what was, on a percentage basis, less than half of what we race for today. Nothing was negotiated. The racetrack dictated purses which for their own purposes were considered decent. If the horsemen didn't like it, they could go elsewhere to race or not race at all. It wasn't quite slavery, but it was not even remotely related to a fair and equitable system. Dad, as the president of UHHA, negotiated on behalf of the horsepeople and as a result the Quebec racing industry prospered."

You've been involved with several generations of great horsemen. Can you please speak of several?

"For horsemen of the era in which I grew up, there was only one man. Behind him there were all the rest. That man was Keith Waples. To steal from Shakespeare in describing Julius Caesar,

'He bestrode the world like a colossus.' But that wasn't Keith's way. He was just a good man endowed with great talent and dedication. As others have said about him, if you followed and lived your life as he did, you wouldn't go wrong. I was one of the speakers at the celebration of life dinner held at Mohawk last fall. It was one of the greatest honors ever bestowed on me.

"Behind Keith, I would rate Herve Filion as the most monumental. He was a man so much ahead of his time. He was perhaps more equine than human. For a man who was relatively uneducated, he did what very few in any profession have done. He rose to the very top and stayed there for as long as anyone. He was driving horses at the age of 15 better than anybody not named Waples. There were likely two main reasons why he didn't become all that he might have become. The first was his lack of education; not that he wasn't very smart, he certainly was. But he was street smart, not business smart. The second was that horrible fire that destroyed his stable of quality horses; horses that it had taken a lifetime of hard work to put together. He had been sitting on the top of the world with one of the greatest racing stables ever assembled. Not like most trainers of today, Herve owned them all. It was a wound that would have destroyed lesser men. But he was Herve and he still managed to continue doing what he had done all of his life.

"Behind Herve would come a photo finish of great drivers led by John Campbell, Bill O'Donnell, Ron Waples, Michel Lachance, Ronnie Pierce and Cat Manzi. I would be remiss in not mentioning three of the greatest horsemen who in their own way were responsible for the growth of our great sport: Stanley

Dancer, Billy Haughton and Delvin Miller. Today's youthful drivers are very, very impressive. I really like Yannick Gingras, perhaps because I knew and raced against his father Raymond and his grandfather Marc. I worked as a trainer/driver from 1969 through 1982. I loved the game. I still do. Any time there is an important race going on, whether it's the North America Cup, the Hambletonian or the Breeders Crowns I try to do my best to get there to see them."

Let's talk about politics. What got you involved?

"I was always curious and always had this insouciant sort of behavior. I was 14 years old and decided to go to Ottawa to meet the Prime Minister, Lester B. Pearson. Wouldn't you know it, I managed to get the job done. Mr. Pearson was a great man. History now recognizes him as one of our greatest prime ministers ever. He met with this brash young farm kid from Pembroke, ON. Can you imagine if someone would try to do this today? Not a chance.

"As for me, my political interest was piqued after I stopped drinking alcohol at the age of 35. Believe me, it was a very good lifestyle decision for me to quit the booze. My immediate concern was how to fill the void. I had run for student prime minister while in high school and recalled liking it so I started sniffing around and went to a political convention. I decided to run for the Liberal nomination in my district. In retrospect it might not have been the wisest decision I've ever made. The

sitting Member of Parliament had occupied the seat for 25 years. Nevertheless, I ran and probably did better than anybody expected. I received 49.5 per cent of the vote with my opponent getting 50.5 per cent.

"The next time I ran I won. I served as federal member of parliament for the riding of Renfrew-Nipissing-Pembroke. In the election of 2000, I took a very unpopular stand on gun control and lost by a small margin. I was in favor of gun control and everything that went with it. My district is quite rural with lots of its constituents not being in favor of gun control. I've often been asked if I had it to do over would my stance be different? My answer is no way! My standing response is to look at the multiple shootings on a daily basis in the United States. Contrary to the way some might think, there has to come a time where character is more important than expedience. The Republican Party should do the right thing instead of the easy thing and support qun legislation."

You have met with some great politicians. Let's hear about some of them.

"Lester Pearson — One of, if not the greatest prime minister. He never held a clear majority in all the years that he was Prime Minister. Yet he was able to achieve so much. He was a world leader admired by just about everyone. He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. He was known as a man who reached across political boundaries. He was also a great athlete. He never really got the credit he deserved while in office. Much like Harry Truman in the U.S.A. he is now recognized as one of our greatest leaders.

"Jean Chretien – I suppose you might describe him as my "rabbi." He headed the Liberal party when I was one of its MPs. When I

was defeated in 2000, he offered me the job of being a special advisor for his caucus. I suppose you could describe the job as being similar to the man that holds the keys to the vault. The members of parliament and the senators would come to me looking for an opportune time to meet with the Prime Minister. I travelled the world with him meeting other world leaders. He is now 89 and is as sharp as a tack. I just spoke with him on

Sunday. He sounds just great. One of my favorite stories about him was when we were in the United States before the Trump-Clinton election. Hillary Clinton had taken a few days off during the campaign because she felt ill. Mr. Chretien was asked if he thought that was a good idea. Chretien responded, 'Hilary can take some medicine, some pills and quickly get better but [with obvious reference to Trump], there is no pill for stupidity.'

"Pierre Elliot Trudeau — was a great leader. If not for him I have my doubts as to whether Canada would be a whole country today. If not for his actions during the FLQ crisis I doubt Quebec would still be part of the country. After my election loss, he called and asked that I meet with him in Montreal. He praised me for my forbearance. One thing that he said to me was, 'You know Hector, you and I share the same birthday October 18.' I said I was amazed that he knew that. 'Hector,' he responded. 'Don't you think that the Prime Minister of Canada should know something about the person with whom he was meeting?' After he passed away, I received a special request from his family to attend his funeral. It was my honor to be there."

Let's talk about Hector Clouthier, the athlete.

"I don't know about being an athlete. But I am a firm believer about staying in shape. I run 12 kilometers every day. I've run 45 marathons since the age of 51. I ran the 2022 Boston Marathon at age 72. It was the eighth time I ran Boston, but unfortunately, I did not qualify for the 2023 race. But I'm looking forward to the New York Marathon this year on the Sunday prior to the Harrisburg sale. The New York Marathon is my all-time favorite. There is no city remotely like New York. At 73, I still play competitive hockey and especially enjoy playing with my son and grandsons on the outdoor ice."

What occupies Hector Clouthier's life these days.

"My wife Debbie and I enjoy traveling a great deal. I'm in the process of writing another book. Also, I'm the campaign chair raising funds for a \$24.6 million-dollar redevelopment project for a senior citizen complex in Pembroke. I still follow harness racing assiduously trying to watch or attend all the most important races whenever and wherever I can."

Author's note: If you are ever at an important race somewhere in North America, look for an elfin appearing man wearing a bright fedora. Chances are that you will have encountered Hector Clouthier. I will make you a promise, you will never forget the encounter. We talk about "one of a kinds." Nobody fits that description better.

Breaking down Monday's Borgata and Matchmaker series stakes

Between the rich finals for the MGM Borgata and Blue Chip Matchmaker series, as well as their consolations, Monday's Pick-5 at Yonkers will consist entirely of the stakes races. Beginning in Race 5, a \$10,000 guaranteed pool will be offered, concluding in Race 9 with the Borgata Final. Here's my breakdown of the races.

Race 5, \$0.50 Pick-5 ticket: 1 / 1-5-7 / 1-3-4 / 1-2-3 / 1-3-8 = \$42

RACE 5, \$75,000 BLUE CHIP MATCHMAKER CONSOLATION

Delitfulcatherin N did well for herself last week to fend off Drama Act when that heavy favorite attacked early from the pocket and was game to lose only to a resurgent Racine Bell who will be one of the favorites later in the card in the series final. Her race two back against that same rival was just as good and even going four back, she was fighting on despite longshot status when she broke. This is her chance to shine and the Gillis barn remains sharp. I'll likely use her as a single in the Pick-5 sequence, so it could be an early exit if I'm wrong. Gotthegreenlight hasn't been bad in this series, but has shown how difficult it can be for a 4-year-old against these tougher, more seasoned mares. She'll attract support once again as the connections must be respected, but I'm not sold enough to include her. Mabalene N is another that should take support but still needs to prove it. She had every chance last out to get to Lucky Artist and had it easy on the front end two back when she was caught. Gia's Surreal came first over last week but never caught onto the leader; has been stronger in years past.

RACE 6, \$50,000 MGM BORGATA FFA CONSOLATION #2

Anothrmastrpiece N was done in by bad posts throughout this series, which was unfortunate considering how well he came into this series off that try against Leonidas in an open race in early March. Even last week he wasn't handled too aggressively and then had to alter course a couple of times into the stretch before flattening late. Lands another bad post but this is a field he can do some damage in. Splash Brother was racking up big wins in fast times in lesser conditions and then decided to give the Borgata a try in the final preliminary leg. He got stuck in that race behind Bee Two Bee who folded rapidly and will get another chance in this consolation to show he can go with these; I think he can. Tough call on Jack's Legend. He got a confidence building win last out and now steps up again. He'd have crushed these in years past, likely to push the pace from the rail. Rockinwithelvis A tried to secure early position last out and gradually tired later in the mile; could surprise.

RACE 7, \$100,000 MGM BORGATA FFA CONSOLATION #1

Hemsworth N is another that wasn't done any favors at the post draws and he too entered this series with momentum. He won the only preliminary leg in which he had a halfway



decent post. Last week he was flying from the clouds and he has a big shot in here; I'd expect he will take action off that 10-1 morning line. The big question here is what to do with Tattoo Artist. He had the rail this time last year in the series final and now lands it in the consolation but under more questionable form. His best would obviously be more than good enough just like it was four races ago, but I have no idea what to expect and wouldn't be surprised by anything. American Courage has tried the front end in two of his four races this year and was caught both times; albeit by superior horses. He did win two back when raced from off the pace, so it'll be interesting to see what Kakaley does here; may still try to get a forward early position. Priceless Beach couldn't keep up with the cover of that blitz from Backstreet Shadow from leq #4 and then took last week off. Could surprise, just like he did in winning an open here at the end of February.

RACE 8, \$328,000 BLUE CHIP MATCHMAKER FINAL

Doug's Babe rates 5-1 in the morning line for the Matchmaker final and may very well be favored come race time. She enters the final off three straight wins, the most impressive of which was when she beat Amazing Dream N two back in a race where those two were well clear of all the others. She followed up that win with a lifetime best 1:51.2 win last week and will not be ignored going for Norman and Dunn. Amazing Dream N has drawn favorably this entire series and the final here is no exception. She had a great duel with Doug's Babe in her most recent race two weeks ago and a super showdown could be coming once again. What more can you say about Racine Bell? She loves this track, has shown up throughout the series and won last week when it looked like she had gapped off cover until the very end when she finally kicked into gear. It's a near certainty that the winner of this race will come from the inside three. Drama Act has had it mostly her own way throughout the series but probably hasn't been as strong as she should have.

RACE 9, \$511,000 MGM BORGATA FFA FINAL

Going by some of the auto-generated morning lines throughout the card and in particular for a race of this quality, we might not be too far from having ChatGPT doing this type of work. Programmed 2-1 favorite This Is The Plan only got into this race with the defection of the injured Jimmy Freight. Winner of this series final two years ago from post eight, he comes off his best race yet of the year, going wire to wire last out over a lesser group but in a solid time of 1:50.4. He'll need to step it up even more but it's Burke and Gingras so he theoretically could do just that; any top finishing effort would push his career earnings over \$3 million. Covered Bridge has simply been vicious in his last pair. He exploded from nowhere last week when he wasn't very well positioned and two back, he drew off impressively late despite a first over trip. The rail may not necessarily be the best place for him but he's impossible to leave off the ticket; one of the many super sharp horses in here. Idealsomemagic flew last week to track down Funatthebeach and turn the tables on that rival from their late duel two back. With Stratton remaining committed to defending champion Funatthebeach, Brennan has stated this week he feels Idealsomemagic may be best from coming off the pace so it's possible he could be raced that way in this final. What do we think of Backstreet Shadow at 20-1? Without a doubt he'd be the race favorite if not for post eight, but what a massive equalizer. He's only two races removed from that record 1:49.3 performance and last week he closed with a rush in a race that was strictly being used to stay fresh for the final. What would be a fair price from out here, 5-1? Lochinvar Art has seen his stock fall in recent weeks. After not being as strong in the third leg as he had been prior, he took a week off and then once again didn't fire last out. Is now suddenly a big longshot. Leonidas A and Hellabalou have been well supported throughout the series but feel they'd need a little luck to contend in this spot for the top.







The orderly rise of No Control

From value-priced yearling to Ontario Sired Spring Series favorite.

Canada's fastest 3-year-old pacer of 2023 was set to return this Saturday night (April 22) at Woodbine Mohawk Park (after this story was filed), facing nine other colts and geldings in the Ontario Sired Spring Series Final. No Control (p, 3, 1:51.4s; \$26,871) drew post 10 after capturing both preliminary legs for driver Tyler Jones, setting the seasonal record for his division with ease last Friday night (April 14).

No Control swept past leader Artsalive at the quarter pole, reached in :27.4, and maintained advantage on the front end for the remainder of the mile. Unchallenged through the :56.4 half and 1:25 three-quarters, driver Jones glanced back in deep stretch. Fast-closing Nightime Dancer passed pocket-sitting Artsalive for place, but No Control had no trouble reaching the wire over two lengths ahead of them.

"I was looking back to gauge the distance between other horses," Jones said. "I knew Jody [Jamieson] was driving a decent horse [Nightime Dancer]. I wanted to make sure No Control was going to win, albeit with some reserve. Simply trying to manage the horse and ration his speed while he's still learning to race."

Announcer Ken Middleton summed up the decisive finish: "No Control barely took a deep breath as he wins the Ontario Sired Spring Series in 1:51.4, home in :26.4 under a death grip."

The gelded son of Control The Moment—Dani Hanover is owned by trainer Tan Micallef of Moffat, ON, Keira Liberte of Hagersville, ON and Ian Clarke of Guelph, ON.

His story is not that of the typical "glamor boy." Micallef called him "the underdog.

"He is the second foal of an unraced dam," Micallef said. "Dani Hanover's firstborn, Head Honcho (p, 4, 1:56.4s; \$21,025) overcame a stall injury to come back with three wins this year,

the most recent at Mohawk. He was unraced when [No Control] was going through the [2021] sale. So, the mare had nothing. He was a good-looking horse too, Head Honcho, in the video."

Dani Hanover was being offered in the 2021 Harrisburg mixed sale, selling in foal to Control The Moment.

"He's not Captaintreacherous, but I like them, myself," Micallef said.

The Art Major—Danielles All Aces mare was sold to Crystal Springs Farm of Millerburg, OH for just \$7,000.

No Control sold for just \$9,000 as a yearling at the 2021 Harrisburg sale and has made just five lifetime starts, all at Mohawk for Jones and Micallef. After winning his first qualifier there on Dec. 2, 2022, the 2-year-old gelding closed in a brisk :26.2 for show in his first race, Dec. 8. He broke his maiden Dec. 22, 2022, opening up by five lengths to take a freshman mark of 1:53. At publication deadline, he was undefeated in his last four starts, winning each by a length or more.

The gelding's freshman debut at Mohawk wasn't postponed by any issues preventing an earlier start.

"That was my own decision," Micallef said. "I didn't even pay him up to the Ontario Sires Stakes as a 2-year-old because I didn't want to push him. I mean, realistically, we paid \$9,000 for him... If you get a racehorse, that's great. If you get a good racehorse, that's even better, right? But for \$9,000... You know, I'm just being realistic."

The trainer's objective was simply to have a "nice 3-year-old" who could go on to compete as an overnight horse at his home track.

"He's lightly raced because that was the plan anyway," Micallef said. "We'll take it easy with him. He showed some talent. At the end of December, we gave him a break and then brought him back for April."

When not on the track, No Control is usually turned out at Micallef's farm, a short distance from Mohawk.

"He's out like 24-7," he said. "He's got his own shed, he's got hay out there. I mean, if I was a horse, I wouldn't want to be in a stall 23 hours a day... I look at it from their perspective."

Micallef said he's pleased with the big brown gelding's progress and personality.

"He's really good," he said. "He loves being outside. I'll jog him for half an hour, I'll do him up and he goes right back out, that's pretty much it. If he missed a week [of racing] I train him; otherwise, I just jog him."

He noted that No Control's regular driver shared his high opinion of the gelding: "I know Tyler [Jones] likes him a lot."

Jones agreed: "I knew when I first sat behind him, in a schooling race and then in his first qualifier, that he was a strong horse. In his third lifetime start, he showed me that he had a quick

turn of foot and a nice long stride when I let him pace at the five-eighths pole. Since then, it's just been trying to piece things together for him so he can develop into a versatile racehorse."

No Control's rapid rise is evident in his odds for the Ontario Sired Series Final.

"He has the ten hole on Saturday," Micallef said. "He's still 6-5 morning line [favorite]."

The pacer has captured more attention every race, also becoming a favorite of a Woodbine Mohawk Park racing analyst.

"We liked him anyway, right?" Micallef said. "But the way Randy Waples talks about him... He pumped him up."

No Control will be even more visible in the coming months at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"I paid him into the Somebeachsomewhere and I paid him into the [North America] Cup," Micallef said, adding that the Ontario Sires Stakes will be on No Control's 2023 schedule as well. "I skipped the 2-year-old year, but he's paid for the 3-year-old year... If he's a nice OSS 3-year-old pacer, he can make money there, too."

Coming back to the races this season, No Control disproved his name.

"I thought maybe as he got older, he might get a bit more aggressive, but when he qualified this year, I don't know if you noticed, but the first quarter was like :31.1 and he sat in the hole, which is what I wanted," Micallef said. "No problem driving him, no problem at all."

Micallef is also the paddock blacksmith at Woodbine Mohawk Park. He said a shoeing change played a small but significant part in No Control's success.

"Last year, he had steel shoes," he said. "When I turned him out, I put the flip-flops on him after December. I brought him back with the flip-flops on and I trained him down and I qualified him with the flip-flops on. He didn't seem to be pacing as good. He looked like he was kind of spinning his wheels. I thought the track was quite deep, so I kind of let that one go, the qualifier.

"Then in his first start, he still wasn't pacing quite right. He still won it. So, then I changed him back to steel last week and I could tell he was pacing better. The flip-flops can't grab the track as well... The blacksmith part, I guess it does help, a little bit."

No Control and Dani Hanover have rapidly become more interesting than their 2021 Harrisburg sale prices would have suggested. Micallef said he wondered about 2-year-old Beyond Control, the younger full brother to No Control.

"I was looking for him," he said.

He learned the colt was privately purchased by Douglas Wilson of Dorchester, ON.

As for Dani Hanover, Ray Yoder of Crystal Springs Farm laughed out loud when he was reached for an interview.

"I looked her up the other day and I was like, 'Doggone, I should have kept her!" Yoder said with a laugh.

The mare lost her 2022 foal, her fourth colt by Control The Moment.

"She had foaling complications," Yoder said. "We got the colt out... He got an infection in a joint and we ended up having to put the colt down. I was down in the dumps about it."

Disappointed, he sold Dani Hanover last summer, before her two sons of racing age had started winning.

"Her page was still blank, like none of them had done anything, so I actually don't have the mare anymore," Yoder said. "I basically just gave her to my brother-in-law. I don't even know if she's breeding sound or not... She is probably pulling a buggy right now."

Yoder said he would be taking a second look at Dani Hanover's broodmare potential, no longer a blank slate thanks to No Control and Head Honcho.

"I'm going to be on the phone here very shortly; we're going to do some tracking down," he said. "When I sold the mare, there was not much activity happening at all. Ain't that the way the cookie crumbles."

There is no certainty in harness racing, in breeding or on the track. Going into the Ontario Sired Spring Series Final, Micallef was cautiously optimistic about No Control's chances.

"Well, we'll see anyway," he said. "Hopefully it keeps going. Just keep the fingers crossed."





Joviality splendid in first European start

Courant Stable's 4-year-old Chapter Seven daughter **Joviality** showed up for the European harness racing fans for the first time when eliminations to the Drottningpokalen were held at Åby racetrack on Friday (April 21) night.

And trainer Sabine Kaghebrant's new star didn't disappoint anyone when she played with the opponents from the lead as she hit the wire in a mile rate of 1:57 over 1.3 miles.

Joviality looked just perfect all the way in the hands of Erik Adielsson and she will be the horse to beat in the final on May 6.

ETONNANT IN ATLANTIQUE

The Richard Westerink-trained **Etonnant** (Timoko) continues to win after his sickness break during the Paris' winter meeting. The horse's third consecutive win during the spring came in the \$215,000 Prix de l'Atlantique at Enghien racetrack in Paris on Saturday (April 22) afternoon.

Etonnant, who hit a spot in sixth over after a very safe start on driver Anthony Barrier's part, was pushed three-wide with a little less than a mile to go and with a half-mile remaining in the race, Etonnant was in front.

Early leader Hohneck got his chance to challenge Etonnant in the stretch, but he couldn't get close to the winner. Instead, another horse finished strongly from a bad position. The Romain Derieux-trained Go On Boy picked up many lengths on the winner in Enghien's long home stretch and finished second ahead of Hohneck.

The mile rate for Etonnant was 1:54.1 over 1.3 miles and the title defender in the Elitloppet will really be ready for a new

battle in Stockholm at the end of May. Joining him on the journey from France will be Go On Boy. Solvalla invited Go On Boy to the Elitloppet after his strong effort at Enghien on Saturday afternoon.

The Philippe Allaire trained **Just A Gigolo** (Boccador de Simm) did his first start since Jan. 8 when he entered the \$125,000 Prix de Tonnac-Villeneuve at Enghien and the dominant 4-year-old was outstanding from the lead as he won in a mile rate of 2:01.4 over 1.7 miles.

Mister Hercules took control of the race as the field turned for home, but he had to show big moral and strength to win the race. The Daniel Wäjersten trained Borups Victory finished very strongly after a three wide last turn and got close to Mister Hercules in the end. Mister Hercules held on and won in a mile rate of 1:55.2.

Green trotters pass first test for Essig

Last season, trotting filly Swanya made one start at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing and Casino, breaking stride during the mile and finishing eighth. Trainer Missy Essig turned the immature freshman out and pointed to 2023. Now 3, Swanya returned to action in The Mya Tri series, completing a sweep Wednesday (April 19). Another Essig charge, sophomore Helpfirstedition, captured the \$18,000 final of the Cardinal Series that same night in similarly impressive fashion. The two are pointed to Indiana Sires Stakes competition in late May.

"We have more luck turning 2-year-olds out and bringing them back at 3," Essig said. "If they're showing that they are not ready and you're going to do more damage than good, we would just rather turn them out and let them grow."

With Swanya, Essig said the filly just couldn't put it all together to race successfully as a freshman. The Swan For All lass qualified last July, winning in a time of 2:01.2. Ten days later, she would make her pari-mutuel debut, racing off the pace early before breaking. Eight days after that first start, she would run again in a qualifier.

"Swanya just couldn't get it all together as a 2-year-old," Essig said. "She was just mentally and physically not there. We turned her out in July. We brought her back in December when we went to Pinehurst. Obviously, she has a great family, so we just turned her out and hoped that she would come back a good 3-year-old like her big brother."

Swanya sold for \$25,000 at the 2021 Hoosier Classic Sale, purchased by Essig's mother, Jackie Beeman. The Swan For All filly is out of the Lou's Legacy mare Tanya's Legacy. Her mother, Yaichbin Bluegrass, is a sister to a pair of Indiana Sires Stakes final winners, B L Sugar An Spice and Yadubist Bluegrass. Swanya is a full-sister to \$500,000 winner Whata Swan, whose 1:50.3 mark is a Hoosier Park track record.

While the filly struggled last year, at Pinehurst, Essig observed a different horse training down.





"She was just a totally different horse," Essig said. "She's been great since we brought her back in. She trained down great and didn't have any funky quirks. She did everything perfect all winter long, so we had high hopes for her. You never want to get your feelings crushed, but we felt very good going into the series."

After a pair of March qualifiers, Swanya debuted as a sophomore in the \$9,000 opening leg of The Mya Tri with a winning effort. Driven by John DeLong from the second tier, the trotter left the gate third, but pushed to the front through a :59.4 opening half. From there, she won comfortably in 1:58. She would back that effort up a week later, leaving from the outside to take command before stopping the clock in 1:57, winning by more than two lengths. In Wednesday's final, DeLong secured the lead after the quarter and the pair won by five lengths with a 1:56.2 clocking.

"John said she's still very green," Essig said. "He thinks she's just going to keep getting better as she catches on. She's still really a baby racing."

Like Swanya, Helpfirstedition entered 2023 with little experience, but lots of potential. From the first crop of Helpisontheway, the gelding romped in a qualifier last July, finishing nearly 18 lengths in front with a 2:01 performance. Owned by Ervin Wickey, John Graber, Running Wild Stables and John Schmucker, the trotter sustained an injury before

making his freshman debut and was promptly turned out to heal and grow.

"He was training down really well," Essig said. "He showed a lot of potential. He had an injury that set him back so we just quit with him and turned him out."

She believes the extra time served Helpfirstedition well. The gelding remained in Indiana over the winter. After qualifying in March for Jesse Schmucker, the sophomore was turned over to Essig. He won his second qualifying attempt and then recovered from an early interference break in his debut to finish fourth. In the Cardinal Series, Helpfirstedition triumphed in 1:58.1 and 1:56 before handily claiming victory Wednesday by a four and one-half length margin, crossing the wire in 1:55.3.

"He really matured," Essig said. "He's another one that is just a really nice horse to be around. I think the time off was the best thing for him."

The pair of trotters and Indiana Sires Stakes hopefuls join a roster that already includes champion Buzzsaw Russ and one of last season's top freshman trotters, Texsong Soprano. Buzzsaw Russ won four of nine 2-year-old starts, capping the campaign with a 1:50.2 triumph in the \$270,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final. The son of Rockin Image finished the year with \$235,460 on his card for Essig's father, Russ Beeman and his partner, Charles Weaver. Buzzsaw Russ qualified for the


first time Wednesday, guided to victory by DeLong through a 1:52.2 circuit.

"He's trained well all winter too," Essig said. "We had him in Pinehurst. I was really kind of shocked he qualified in [1]:52, but very pleased. It wasn't going to hurt him any, because he was ready. We'll qualify him again on Wednesday and try to get a start in him before sires stakes. He's not really tall, but he did grow. When I put his harness back on him, I had to let everything out two or three holes. So, he did grow over the winter. But he's not a huge horse either."

As of this writing, Essig has yet to lay eyes on Texsong Soprano, the Text Me sophomore that hit the board in nine of 10 last year, winning five times and banking \$174,722 for the trainer. Owned by Lillian Farms and Joe D. Yoder, the trotting colt wintered in northern Indiana and was set to ship to Madison County on Saturday (April 22). She is anxious to see how the multiple Indiana Sires Stakes leg winner handled the offseason.

"I get him back tomorrow," she said on Friday afternoon. "He'll be back in the barn tomorrow and we'll train him up a couple times and get him qualified. Hopefully he'll be ready to go."

The rocking horse winner

Most mornings find me at McDonald's or Panera, just me and my iPad tented on a table, the daily edition of the *New York Times* on the screen. My solitary breakfast routine makes eavesdropping on conversations at nearby tables possible. Occasionally, the topics are interesting.

Regular groups begin to drift into McDonald's beginning at 8. They dive into their McMuffin sandwiches, Big Breakfasts and senior coffees (with free refills) at two tables in front of the glass wall separating the dining area from the children's playroom. This morning, COVID fears and a heavy snowfall thinned their ranks. Only two gentlemen made the scene, my favorite two. I knew their backgrounds from previous mornings of listening in on their conversations.

The professor, I never caught his last name, is a retired American Literature instructor with Albert Einstein hair. His breakfast friends refer to him as Professor Point due to his habit of bouncing his index finger off the tabletop when he gets wound up and has a point to get across. The professor points constantly.

Rocco Risko, an elfin figure nearing 90, looks, talks, walks and dresses like he is on his way to audition for the role of Harry the Horse, the crook and gambler in *Guys and Dolls*. Rocco retired from working at horse racing backstretches across America.

On this wintery COVID morning, I pushed the record app on my cell phone.

"Americans who read serious literature were a minority when I taught and it worsens daily. Those electronic devices are ruining minds."

"I started reading race programs in the back row of Saint Barnabas Elementary and never lost the habit. If you stacked every racing program I studied side by side, whoa baby, they would be thicker than 50 of those *Encyclopedia Britannica* sets they used to sell door to door."

"Didn't you ever read books?"

"Comic books. You might not know this professor, but in the '60s, certain comic books, like *Tom Swift* or *Classics Illustrated*, had a lot of words."

"I'm speaking about literature, real books."

"No, you are pontificating like a hoity-toity smart-ass talking down to a classroom of rich kids."

"Sorry, I get passionate about books."

"No problem. Passion is good. One of the nuns at Saint Barnabas, sister Grace, loaned me a copy of *Black Beauty* in the sixth grade. She told me to read it and then explain to the class what it was all about. It looked like too many words, so I went to the movie, you know, the one with Elizabeth Taylor."

"Elizabeth Taylor was not in Black Beauty. She was in National Velvet."

"Really, huh? That explains why my review didn't go over big."

"Did you read any other classic books?"

"As a teenager, I got kicked by a horse. While recuperating, my Aunt Zelda left me the whale book, *Moby Dick*, to kill time. I struggled through a few pages, put it down and slogged some more. I gave it the old college try for three days. The book did not stick. Now the movie *Jaws*, I loved that."

"Each term for 27 years, it was my task to convince students that the classic books on the college curriculum were not "pieces of s -- t." I strove mightily to turn minds toward an appreciation of literature. How often did I succeed, you ask?"

"I ain't asking nothin."

"Who can say? Most college students don't admit classes teach them anything. However, I believe I planted seeds concerning the fine authors that America has produced."

"I read sales catalogs about harness racing yearlings. I can read them all night and all day and sales catalogs can be as thick as family bibles. Those pages stick in my head like flypaper."

"Horses racing? That reminds me of one of my favorite American short stories, The Rocking-Horse Winner by D.H. Lawrence, written in 1926, in Harper's Bazaar and subsequently, in Lawrence's collected stories. It's been made into movies and plays. None can hold a candle to the written word."

"Why do writers use initials, like H.G. Wells, the science fiction quy?"

"I don't know. I never considered that excellent question: E.B. White, C.S. Lewis, H.P. Lovecraft, J.R.R. Tolkien, J.D. Salinger."

"If I ever write a book, I'm going with B.S. Risko."

"The Rocking-Horse Winner is about a boy named Paul. His family is middle class, always complaining about needing money. Young Paul secretly provides funds. He does this by riding his rocking horse until he enters a trance-like state, where he can 'predict' the horse's name that will win the next big horse race. He does this often, winning significant sums of

money. His Uncle Oscar, who learns about the rocking horse trick, prods him to continue. Eventually, however, Paul rides his rocking horse with such fury that he collapses and upon hearing the news that he has won a large fortune from his latest horse race bet, Paul dies."

"Whoa, professor, what a downer. Who in the hell wants to read a book like that?"

"Literature opens the minds. People use their imagination to interpret a story like this. Is this a horror story? Is it about family relationships? Most interpretations of this story are that if you expend all your energy trying to make money, it will destroy you."

"Or maybe the moral of this big deal story is that the kid should have stuck to picking winners using the racing program."

Emily Hay – Owner / trainer / driver

The fact that Emily Hay's family was not involved in harness racing didn't stop her from making the sport her life and passion.

Hay's start in the business was rather different than most people.

Although she and her brother grew up (4-H) taking their cows, chickens, turkeys and sheep to the fairs, her introduction came when a note was left on her house door by a neighbor.

Call it fate, luck, or merely a coincidence, but in 2009 when a neighbor left a note offering a "free" male racehorse to Hay, she called her friend Bobby Werner asking his advice.

"Although I grew up farming and surrounded by animals, I knew nothing about harness racing or standardbreds," Hay said. "When Bobby asked me, 'Is it a pacer or trotter?' I replied, 'It's a horse.' Up until then I had seen races at Darke County Fair and knew the name Chip Noble."

The gifted horse was a 4-year-old named Aloha Kelly, but his barn name was Joe.

"Bobby helped me get started or should I say, he basically threw me to the wolves, for I was completely in the dark," Hay said. "He taught me a lot and I'll never forget my first race check of \$900 from Hoosier Park that Aloha Kelly made.

"Horsewoman Jamie McComber explained about claiming races

where my horse had to race. Bobby had never mentioned it to me for he knew if I understood the game, I never would have probably raced Joe. But Joe is the one who pushed me to eventually get my trainer and driver's license."

Racing her horses mostly at the Ohio Fair circuit, Hay has also raced at Hoosier Park in Indiana, Northville in Michigan and Northfield Park in Ohio.

"My favorite track is Hoosier Park, but when I raced at Northville I brought along my son, Colton to the paddock to help me," Hay said. "When Colton was in the locker room someone told him 'This room is for drivers only,' so the next time we raced there Colton wore his set of colors [which resembled that of driver Josh Sutton]. When the Michigan Racing Commission had the drivers blow in the breathalyzer and they saw Colton, they told him, 'You have to blow, too.' When he did, they told him, 'he wasn't over the limit on hot chocolate so he could drive."

Currently Hay owns two harness horses and two barrel racing horses and, of course, Hunter the pony (whose real name was Real Hanover, but was named after driver Hunter Myers).

Her favorite horses are Mr I Am, as he was the one who got Hay her first win and T Red, a classy horse that only cost \$800.

"I drove T Red at the fairs the year COVID hit, in the Ohio Ladies Pace Series [now called the Spring Haven Farm Ladies Driving Series]," Hay said. "Red had to get special permission to race for he was 15-years-old. Every time he raced, he gave his all and I feel honored to have had the opportunity to sit behind: a legend. My son who was six at the time would jog Red as he was so easy going.

"T Red gave me the most driving wins and when fairs season ended [along with the help of Henry Gulley], we taught T Red his new career, to run barrels and poles. Red and Henry had a 'love/ hate' relationship for Red pushed Henry's buttons by going after [him] when the horse was in crossties. That old' horse simply loved his job and if there had not been the 15-year-old cutoff to race horses, he would have raced at 16. In his final start in the finals at Delaware in the Ladies Series, Red got nipped at the wire."

But that's not all Hay does in the sport. Along with Bill Peters and Tim Harless (and Ayers Ratliff for several years) she helped run the Spring Haven Ladies Driving Series.

The Series consists of all women drivers at the Ohio Fairs. Each fair has the option to race but they have to front the purse money, then the top point earners go to the final during the prestigious Little Brown Jug Week.

Hay gives credit to the people who helped along the way, such as Werner, Tom Hope, Phil Belanger and Walter Haynes Jr. She also said driver Jason Dillander gave her a bit of advice.

"Stay humble and if you're not you won't be successful," Hay said.

And, of course, Sammy Widger who is probably Hay's favorite driver because "he's just a good down to earth guy.


"There are a lot of people who have helped me and as far as the drivers, they are all really nice and don't make us women drivers feel like we don't belong out there," she said.

Hay also was on the OHHA board for a few years and helped Tim Konkle with Facebook/Twitter and the Midwest Harness Report.

"I've also helped re-home a few standardbreds such as My Ghost [now used for 4-H], Branko [now a trail horse/pet] and we use our horse Real Hanover to help children during camps and to teach people how to ride," Hay said. "I'd love to see a youth membership come into play for kids through OHHA or ISA. There are so many children who would love to learn and be involved.

"The sport is awesome, exciting and I feel totally blessed to have become a part of the harness racing family."

Brennan talks milestone, Borgata and Matchmaker

George Brennan was 14 when he drove a horse to a paycheck for the first time. The teenager, making his only start of 1981, steered Myron's Bunny to a fifth-place finish in an amateur race, with the trotter collecting \$50 in purse money.

At the time, the Monticello, NY, native could not imagine what the future held. Entering Friday (April 21), Brennan has amassed 11,543 career wins, which ranks No. 10 in North American history, received consecutive Driver of the Year awards from the U.S. Harness Writers Association in 2010 and 2011 and captured many of the sport's top races, including the Hambletonian with Broad Bahn and Hambletonian Oaks with Bold And Fresh, both in 2011.

He also has accumulated — since that initial \$50 start — nearly \$199.7 million in purses as he prepares for the first Grand Circuit finals of the season Monday (April 24) at MGM Yonkers Raceway.

Brennan will drive Idealsomemagic A in the \$511,000 MGM

Borgata Series championship for older male pacers and Drama Act in the \$328,200 Blue Chip Matchmaker Series finale for older female pacers, with it conceivable that a good night could boost Brennan to more than \$200 million in purses.

Only six drivers in history have exceeded \$200 million: John Campbell, David Miller, Tim Tetrick, Yannick Gingras, Ron Pierce and Brian Sears.

"When I first started racing at Monticello, I don't know what I was looking for, honestly, I just knew I wanted to race horses," Brennan said, adding that at the time a number like \$200 million in purses was unfathomable. "As far as racing goes that's a huge milestone, which I'm proud of and I'm proud of the company I'm going to be in. That's special. When you look at the six in front of me, I look up to all those guys. I'm very happy about it.

"It's a lot of work, a lot of miles on the road. Like I tell young guys in the game, you've got to show up and you've got to work. You've got to be there every night. When you're there every night, good things happen eventually. It's worked out pretty good for me."

Brennan will look to keep the good times going Monday. Idealsomemagic A, trained by Cory Stratton, led the Borgata standings at the end of the five preliminary rounds of the series thanks to three wins, a second, and a fourth. Brennan drove the 9-year-old gelding in his two most recent starts after driver Jordan Stratton opted to remain with defending series champion Funatthebeach N.

Idealsomemagic A defeated Funatthebeach N by a head last week, completing a rally from fifth place in the last quartermile. The previous week, Idealsomemagic A took the lead at the start, but got nailed by Funatthebeach N nearing the finish line. The margin was a neck.

"He went a great mile on the lead for me two starts back," Brennan said, adding with a laugh, "I actually thought I had Funatthebeach put away, but he wouldn't go away.

"Last week, the plan was to race him from behind and race late. That's what we did, and he picked them up. I personally think he's a little better from behind. The week Jordan won with him from behind [in round one of the series] he just flew home. He paced home pretty good for me,too, last week. But I raced against him enough when he was on the lead and I don't think I ever got by him. So, he's pretty good that way too."



Idealsomemagic A paced his last quarter in :26.4 last week, duplicating the time of his finishing kick in round one. Of the remaining seven horses in the Borgata final, only Backstreet Shadow recorded a sub-:27 last quarter during the series. He did it once, coming home in :26.2 last week to end up third behind Idealsomemagic A and Funatthebeach N.

The draw for the Borgata final finds Idealsomemagic A starting from post three. He is 6-1 on the morning line.

"He's in a pretty good spot; I've got options," Brennan said. "That being said, it's a strong bunch."

This Is The Plan, the 2021 Borgata champion, will leave from post two with Yannick Gingras driving for trainer Ron Burke and is the 2-1 favorite. This Is The Plan, who started from inside post six just once in the five weeks of the series, was ninth in points but joined the field when eighth-place Jimmy Freight was not entered. This Is The Plan heads to the final off a gate-to-wire score from post six last week.

Covered Bridge, who won his starts in rounds four and five, will leave from post one with Tyler Buter driving for trainer Jeff Gillis and is the 5-2 second choice.

In the Blue Chip Matchmaker, defending series champ Drama Act will start from post six with Brennan in the sulky for trainer Burke. The 6-year-old had two wins, one second and two fourths in the prelims. She is 6-1 on the morning line.

"She wasn't as fortunate with the draw this year as she was last year [with post one]," Brennan said. "Four of the speed horses in the race are inside of her. It doesn't look like I can go forward in there, that's for sure. It's not happening, that's the bottom line.

"But she's come back good. I have confidence in her, and I have confidence in the barn she comes from too. She likes the track; she gets around it great and she's versatile. She can win on the lead, she can win from behind, first over; she can do pretty much whatever I want to do with her."

Racine Bell, who raced four times in the series and posted two wins and two seconds, is the 2-1 favorite from post two with Jason Bartlett driving for trainer Dave Dewhurst. Amazing Dream N, with three wins and a second in four prelims, is the 5-2 second choice from post one with Gingras at the lines for trainer Linda Toscano.

Gingras takes both SRF finals at Big M

Yannick Gingras had, what for him, was just another night at the salt mine Friday night (April 21) at The Meadowlands, as the 43-year-old Hall of Fame pilot won both \$40,000 Standardbred Retirement Foundation series finals for 3-year-olds.

In the filly trot, **Sheer Faith**, who tasted defeat in her last two starts at odds of 1-5, got some friends back in her corner, scoring in wire-to-wire fashion in 1:56.2 to record her fifth win from nine lifetime starts as the 2-1 second choice in the wagering.

Gingras rushed the daughter of Better Caviar—Sheer Delight to the lead at the quarter in :28.1, putting 6-5 favorite Bella Macchiato in the pocket.

"We got a little but lucky," Gingras said. "Going into the race I didn't want to cut it. I was hoping those two [Bella Macchiato and The Empress Ice] would go at it, but when Timmy [Tetrick, driving The Empress Ice] went on a break in the first turn, that changed things."

It all looked so easy for the eventual winner, as a big challenge from Jet Zette kept Bella Macchiato with no place to race through the stretch, but nearing the wire, the favorite found some space as Jet Zette weakened.

"I almost messed it up there," said Gingras. "It kinda opened up a little bit too early, but, thankfully, we came out on top."

Sheer Faith, a Per Engblom trainee, returned \$6.20 to win to her backers, holding off Bella Macchiato by a neck. Jet Zette finished third at odds of 70-1.

Always B Naughty won the filly pace as much the best, drawing off to a 6¼-length romp in a lifetime-best equaling 1:51.1. The lightly raced daughter of Always B Miki—Ooh Shesa Badlands, who won a week ago and paid \$2.10, once again returned a nickel on the dollar. She's now won three-of-five starts after not appearing on the track during 2022.

"We turned her out early last year," said winning trainer Nancy Takter. "She was kind of growthy and immature and she was kind of sore, so my owners get all the credit. It's not always easy for owners to agree with the trainer to make those decisions. It played to our favor that she got that extra time that she needed."

Gingras put Always B Naughty on the point and cut out fractions of :27.1, :56.1 and 1:25 before exploding home in :26.1 to win for fun. Always A Dancer held off Ultimate Loulou in the race for place.

"She has Pennsylvania Sire Stakes and Kentucky Sire Stakes coming up," said Takter of her prized pupil. "She's in the Nadia Lobell and the Breeders Crown and the Jugette and some of those other bigger races, so we have to take it race by race and kind of see how she develops, but right now, she shows the speed to be able to do it."

EARLY' GETS UP LATE: Early Action took the overnight feature - a \$20,000 high-end conditioned event on the pace - after a thrilling stretch run that saw the Joe Holloway trainee get up on the wire after sneaking through the inside late before holding off 4-5 public choice Stonebridge Reef by a neck in 1:51.3.

After a huge 2-year-old season that saw him bank over \$400,000, Early Action went winless at 3 during 2022, but the son of Huntsville—Fashion Katie could have a big 2023 after his determined win Friday night.

"Last year was hopeless," Holloway said. "I guess I over raced him at 2, I'm not really sure. But he wouldn't fight at all last year. He did at 2, and so far, this year, he seems more like his 2-year-old self."

As the 9-5 second choice, Early Action paid \$5.60 to win.

THE STREAK LIVES: Needing \$180,000 in action on the 14th and final race of the night, The Big M's streak of \$3 million handles lived on after \$226,878 was pushed through the windows.

All-source wagering for the night was \$3,047,560.

There have been 30 Friday and Saturday night programs contested at The Meadowlands during 2023, and each one has seen betting bust the \$3-million barrier.

During 2022, there were a total of 85 race cards contested at the mile oval, and betting went past the \$3-million plateau 23 times.

A LITTLE MORE: Gingras' four winners led the driver colony while Ron Burke led the trainers with three victory lane jaunts.

USTA to offer scholarships to Racing Official's Accreditation Program

The U.S. Trotting Association is now accepting scholarship applications for the 2023 Racing Official's Accreditation Program (ROAP), which will be held June 18-25 at Saratoga Racecourse in Saratoga, NY.

The 60-hour course provides formal classroom study, covering both basic, day-to-day responsibilities of a judge as well as more technical subjects including medications and drug testing and administrative law and hearings. At the conclusion of the course, students must complete a series of five exams covering the information presented. Current USTA members who plan to attend the 2023 ROAP school are encouraged to apply for a scholarship by completing an **application** and submitting it to **michele.kopiec@ustrotting.com** no later than May 15. Scholarships will be awarded upon completion of the course in varying dollar amounts up to \$2,000 to cover the cost of the school, lodging and other school-related expenses. Additional funds may be available to those who obtain and complete an internship through a USTA member pari-mutuel track.

Notice for horsemen shipping to Oak Grove

Attention horsemen: If you are bringing horses onto the Oak Grove property, it is required by the state of Kentucky that they have a current EIA (Coggins) test dated within the last 12 months and a health paper for each animal entering.

For out of state horses, the health paper must be dated within the last three days (72 hours) and for in-state horses, within the last 10 days. The health papers must also show that the horses have received the EHV vaccine within the last six months.

It's important to make sure that you have physical copies of these documents, as no digital copies will be accepted. When you arrive at the stable gate with your trailer, you will need to present these documents before you may enter.

If you are shipping horses to Oak Grove to stay overnight, they must be in to race or qualify. If you need to overnight your horses, you must call and reserve a stall by 5 p.m. (CDT) on Thursday before the races. Stalls are extremely limited, so it's important to reserve them as soon as possible to ensure that you have a place for your horses to stay. Do not ship horses to Oak Grove without contacting the track at 270-984-4310.
