

Tidbits: I loved the way Atlanta looked in the qualifier Saturday morning at the Meadowlands sans trotting hopples. Yannick Gingras gunned her into the first turn and she couldn't have looked any safer. I truly think trotting hopples slow a horse down, especially in the latter stages of a race Without them she could be amazing.

Unfortunately, I cannot give the same praise for what I have always considered the fastest trotter I have ever seen. Greenshoe was fabulous once he left the gate, but the "White Knight" Brian Sears was in a world of trouble keeping the colt's head on straight behind the gate where he proved to be a bundle of nerves.

I don't like to second guess trainers, but as fast a colt as he is — and how slow the gate leaves at the Meadowlands — if his mind is too brittle to accept the stop and go, why not feed him in late? I love the way he sat in a hole for a bit, but I think if he was as comfortable as I thought, Sears would have stayed put a lot longer. They were certainly going fast enough.

After watching the horses that came from Sunshine Meadows perform in the qualifiers, I am convinced that the track there is short. I know it's not fast and I watched some of the 3-year-olds go comfortable miles in 1:56, which would translate to 1:51 or 1:52 at the Meadowlands. Unless they

were sick or under orders to race the first qualifier very easy, I am perplexed by what I witnessed.

Due to the late scratch of Omaha Beach due to an entrapped epiglottis I will go with my close second choice, Game Winner, to become Bob Baffert's sixth winner in the Kentucky Derby.

For your reading pleasure, I have a historical novel that I loved. Beneath A Scarlet Sky by Mark Sullivan. Based on a true story, Pino Lella, a normal teenager in love with food and girls, is sent away to a Catholic school in the Alps when the bombs start falling in Milan in 1943. He is a character you will immediately fall in love with. He survives impossible situations and has the heart of a lion. The book took an amazing amount of research and is very well written.

Dan Roland asks: (I have shortened a long question) When training 2-year-old trotters, what are the most important and controllable things to focus on to give a trainer the most chance of success?

A colt must be comfortable. Don't ever jam one into equipment. Bridle, girth, headcheck must all be loose fitting. Make sure that if there is any interference you address it immediately. It is especially dangerous when they touch somewhere at a jog. This can erupt in a myriad of bad habits and literally ruin a colt if not corrected in a short period of time. I find that if you start out with a colt barefoot behind and a reverse flat shoe in front with short toes all around the only place he will hit would be to scalp his hind feet. This is easily remedied by putting a pair of pacing scalpers on behind. I like pacing scalpers better than the trotting version as the tend to stay on better.

Don't over-train or over jog. The new version of the trotting horse is more like a thoroughbred and doesn't need to jog more than three miles a day, four is okay, but more than that is counterproductive. There is no necessity to train twice a week. I find giving three or four days off between training sessions is very good.

Diversify your training, it will keep your horses happier than the dull two trips at a mile all the time. Do some interval training, do some longer distance training and make sure that your horses finish their assignments on the bit, never a loose line going to the wire, they will have enough of that when the catch drivers start their jobs. Don't teach your colt to go slow. Once they have reached the 2:25 mark, don't be going first trips in pedestrian fashion. A colt should never go the right way of the track slower than the low 2:30s. I hate to see first trips in 2:50, that's great in November.

Check temperatures every morning and tendons and suspensories after work.

You can buy a laser digital thermometer for around \$30. Check the colt's joint temperatures once a week. I have avoided many catastrophes but finding a HOT joint and

addressing the situation immediately.

Horses must go straight, I am not a fan of head poles early on, but a Murphy blind will usually do the trick.

Make sure you get to the blacksmith often enough (2-3 weeks) to not let toe length get out of hand.

Keep an eye on blood counts and blood enzymes and treat the blood to keep the numbers in proper range.

I find I could go on with this for hours, so I am calling it quits now. Just remember less is always better.

Paul London asks: I hear so much how taking shoes off a trotter overseas is a big plus. Why don't more trainers in America do it? Do you think they should show it on the program? Also if taking shoes off a trotter is so good why not with pacers?

To begin with, the horses that race in Europe and are in the limelight are much older and more race hardened than the 2- and 3-year-olds we concentrate on in America.

There are also many track surfaces on the continent that are barefoot friendly, whereas in our country there are very few. A track like Vincennes in Paris is a velvet path with wide sweeping turns that accommodate many barefoot trotters. The only tracks in the U.S. that would even be close to Paris would be the Red Mile and often the Meadowlands. I personally have raced horses barefoot on most tracks here and in Canada. I even broke the track record in Maywood (half-miler) with a colt named Gallantly in the Galt. He was

by Varenne and his dad raced barefoot for most of his career. I am afraid to advise doing it with 2-year-old as I had one founder as a result and have never tried again.

The reason most trainers don't do it is because they are afraid. If you aren't sure in what you are doing it becomes a problem.

The reason why this is hard to implement on the program is that it is usually a game time decision. Not something planned when you put the horse in the box. A sharp trainer wants to see the track condition first hand before deciding to pull shoes.

I will say that most tracks do announce the fact when you inform the equipment checker.

As far as pacers are concerned, I have seen a few barefoot but the reasoning is not there. Taking the weight of the shoe off a trotter will make him go faster if he can trot that way. Pacers today are shod like thoroughbreds. The blacksmith cuts the feet to the blood and slaps on four aluminum shoes. Therefore, you really gain little if any advantage because the weight loss is so minimal (about 3 ounces).

Steve Putnam asks: I wonder what your views are about drivers betting. I have heard that in certain quarters drivers bet often and bet big. Too bad we don't have an integrity rule and no drivers are allowed to bet.

I am not thrilled by the question because you seem to be insinuating evil. The reason I am answering is because I would like to set you straight.

When I started training almost 60 years ago, the money we raced for was minimal and more drivers and trainers bet on horses to supplement their income. I am not talking cheating. Honest gambling was prevalent because on the inside we knew more than the people on the outside whose money made up the majority of the pools. Were there cheaters? For sure there were, but by far the majority of bets that were placed by the trainers and drivers were honest calculated risks. The horse was locked in last week with a ton of pace, or my colt had a lot of mucous pouring from his nose last week, etc. These type of situations provide reason to make a wager.



Today it's a totally different story. Even though many tracks have installed betting machines in the paddocks, the amount of money bet by the drivers today I would guess was less than 10 per cent of what it was in 1960. The top drivers at most major tracks are all millionaires. Do you think they would give up the goose that laid the golden egg to cash a bet? The thought is unfathomable. Take note that if any of these drivers are betting, it's for entertainment not because they need it to feed their family. People like to stir the pot. I get emails of "bad races" my readers want me to watch all the time. Almost always I see nothing wrong at all. If you have never sat behind a horse going 30 or almost 40 mph you are not entitled to a legitimate opinion because split second decisions pass you by in a heartbeat.

Thanks to all my readers for the kind words. We are just a few weeks away from the beginning of the baby races across the country, which, to me, is the most exciting time of the year. Please keep the questions coming. Hopefully I will have my first Road To The Hambletonian ready soon. Have a wonderful week.

Harness racing from morning through night on Derby Saturday

Every year in the week leading up to the Kentucky Derby, I hear from friends I haven't heard from since the last Kentucky Derby, asking who I like in the race. For them and most people, the Kentucky Derby represents one of the only days of the year to bet on horses. For us harness racing enthusiasts though, the benefit of Derby day is that tracks begin earlier than usual to coincide with the early Churchill start time. With added cards and special post times on Saturday beginning as early as 11 a.m. in the East, the day offers over 12 hours of continuous harness racing with a series of top-notch stakes races mixed in. Here's a timeline of what to watch throughout that time.

11 a.m.

Pocono Downs kicks off its doubleheader card with 10 races beginning at a late morning time as the first harness track to begin the day. All 10 races are lower level conditioned races, but it'll be enough to get started until some of the higher-level caliber of racing joins in.

11:25 a.m.

The Meadows begins their card and is highlighted by 3 PASS divisions for 3-year-old pacers, each going for over \$58,000. Race 3 at 12:05pm is the first of the PASS races, and it features last year's Breeders Crown runner-up PROOF.

David Miller is at the track for a day of stakes races and he'll get the drive for Brian Brown. PRINCE OF TIDES didn't make waves in his four starts last year at two, but he's unbeaten in three starts this year throughout the Wiggle It Jiggleit series at the Meadowlands, most recently winning in 1:49:4. The following PASS race immediately after at 12:25pm showcases the return fast 2-year-olds last year, AIR FORCE HANOVER and WORKIN ON A MYSTERY. Both are Brian Brown trainees, and the latter took a mark last year of 1:49:2.

2:20 p.m.

There are two Great Northeast Series races at Harrah's Philadelphia in the afternoon, but it's the second one that should draw all the attention. The open F&M pace features the return of last year's 3-year-old pacing champion KISSIN IN THE SAND following a couple big return qualifiers over foes such as Caviart Ally and Youaremycandygirl. Believe it or not, KISSIN IN THE SAND actually rates third in the morning line. I guess the thinking is that maybe she won't be A-1 ready at first asking? DON'T THINK TWICE A lands morning line favoritism after racing in the Matchmaker at Yonkers and TEQUILLA MONDAY is another short-priced mare in the program. She was a pretty good filly in her own right at age 3 and if there was ever a time she could beat Kissin In The Sand, maybe now would be it – still not likely though.

3:10 p.m.

The Lady Suffolk at Freehold is the first of two major stakes at the track, and the favorite is likely to be MAGIC BELIEFS. Going for Linda Toscano, this one made good money last year at two in stakes such as the Liberty Bell and Keystone Classic, but I'll take a shot against. GOLDEN TRICKS lands the big post edge for Ake Svanstedt and I'd expect him to be very aggressive in this spot. She raced well at times last year against some of the division's better ones and that qualifier against French Café was solid.

3:30 p.m.

This is the \$118,950 Dexter Cup at Freehold and though it hasn't produced a lot of Hambletonian starters in recent years, it has launched some eventual nice horses and it's one of the first open stakes of the year for the 3-year-old colt trotters. OSTERC is likely to be the heavy favorite. Though he makes his first start of the year, he qualified most recently against a fast pacer by Well Said at Freehold and his qualifying time from that morning seems to be about 20 lengths quicker than anyone else. Smedshammer's horse SKYWAY KON MAN would rate more of a chance if not for post 8.

9:15 p.m.

The first of two \$50,000 divisions of the Graduate series at the Meadowlands for aged pacers includes the return of familiar stakes players from last year. THIS IS THE PLAN did all he could last week in what primarily used as a prep race for tonight, and he was excellent last year when moving to Burke. What are we supposed to do with LATHER UP tonight? The fast, but often erratic, horse qualified back three times, and made a break in his most recent one coming at the Meadowlands – I think you have to let him win if he can.

DORSODURO HANOVER went a giant mile here last year when second in the Meadowlands Pace; divisional champion had bad posts in both return qualifiers.

9:55 p.m.

The largest purse of the day is in this race, the \$175,200 Cutler FFA for open trotters. As usual with these 12-horse fields at the added distance, the race is wide open. CRUZADO DELA NOCHE hasn't yet been able to replicate that performance in the Yonkers International and similar to Lather Up, I'd be willing to let him beat me if he can. PINKMAN won last out and has already equaled his win total from last year; have to give him credit for getting all the way back to the top. My horse in here to take a shot with is GUARDIAN ANGEL As for Lorentzon and Tim Tetrick, he went a number of fast miles last year and I think is better than he gets credit for; could be a force this year. FIFTYDALLARBILL almost always fires and should be respected; brings with him fellow Tetrick, Trace.

10:12 p.m.

The highlight of the back half of Pocono's doubleheader is the \$50,000 Van Rose Memorial Invitational. In the race, WESTERN FAME makes his first start following his Levy triumph and it doesn't seem like post 7 should present too much of an issue for Team Allard. HIGHALATOR comes off a sharp front-end score against open company at the Meadowlands last out and he has a good history at Pocono; owns a ton of early speed.

10:35 p.m.

In the last big race of the day, Meadowlands Pace winner Courtly Choice makes his 4-year-old debut. He returns off a couple of dominant qualifiers at Mohawk Park and likely will be rallying from off the pace. DONE WELL qualified in 1:50:4 which represents a career speed mark for him. AMERICAN HISTORY went in 1:47 here last year but wasn't as strong as #4 in that recent qualifier. ALWAYS A PRINCE was a killer last year in Indiana but he also beat horses who competed on the Grand Circuit; I wouldn't be too quick to disregard. THINKBIG DREAMBIG put it all together in the second of the year last year; another that probably will be coming from off the pace in first start back.

A leg up – Bazire dominates in Italy, wins Lotteria with Bel Avis

Jean-Michel Bazire made one of his infrequent journeys away from his home country France on Wednesday afternoon and the trip to Italy was successful.

Bazire is a showman and when he qualified Bel Avis (Ganymede) for the \$279,000 final of the Gran Premio

Lotteria, many fans understood this would end up with a French victory.

Bel Avis made an early break from post one in his elimination, but the 8-year-old Ganymede son showed great speed and strength when he came back and sprinted to safe win in 1:55.1.

Stefan Melander trained Disco Volante (Scarlet Knight) and Björn Goop took a wire to wire 1:55.4 win in the second elimination, while Alessandro Goociadoro's Vetruvio (Adrian Chip) took the last elimination from the lead in 1:55.

Bel Avis was served a perfect trip in second over in the final of Gran Premio Lotteria and when Vitruvio early suffered from puncture on a wheel in the race, Bazire put his focus on disarming leader Disco Volante, a mission that was completed by the top of the stretch.

Bazire lifted his legs in the sky and celebrated the victory mid home stretch when Bel Avis flew to an easy win in 1:54.4.

Hie on Kawartha Downs

After a lifetime in the game, horseman and track superintendent Doug Hie said there's nothing like the summer vibe at the Fraserville, ON track near Peterborough.

Kawartha Downs will kick off its 47th season on May 11 and track superintendent Doug Hie said the five-eighths mile oval is in excellent condition in spite of the tough winter and wet spring Ontario has weathered.

"Because the track never had a horse on it from the end of September last year until the first of April this year, the track was super," said Hie. "It really didn't take a lot to have it right for training, and then yesterday (April 29) we graded it all up."

Hie has seven horses of his own ready to qualify at the Fraserville oval this Saturday, May 4, so the veteran trainer/driver will get a first-hand feel for the surface he has been laboring over for the last month.

Hie's farm is just down the road from Kawartha Downs and the horseman will make the bulk of his starts there this season, but the Cobourg, ON native has seen a lot of North America since he and older brothers Carman and Roger were introduced to standardbreds by their father Clifford in the late 1940s.

"The doctor told him to get a hobby. He said he was



concentrating too much on his business. He used to buy livestock and take it to market," Hie said. "Anyway, it got to be a pretty big business, and one day he was at the doctor's office and the doctor told him, 'You better get a hobby,' so he bought a horse.

"Actually, Garth Gordon's father, Jack Gordon, and dad were partners on the first few horses they had. He eventually sold the trucking business, the livestock business, and we were raised with the horses then full-time. We used to go to the track when we were small kids and eventually it just became full-time for us. Well, it became full-time for dad too, but Carman and Roger and I, it was full-time for us right from the get-go."

After getting his training and driving licenses at 17, Doug Hie was a fixture at Peterborough's Morrow Park and the Orono Fairgrounds before making the leap to the Ontario Jockey Club circuit, stabling a string of horses at Greenwood Raceway in Toronto and Garden City Raceway in St. Catharines.

"The first stake race I won, serious stake race, was a \$50,000 Sires Stake at Garden City Raceway with a 2-year-old trotting filly and that was, I mean that was huge for me at that time. I think I was probably 20, 21 and that was huge to win a \$50,000 race," Hie said. "I was racing for \$200 and \$150 at Orono and Morrow Park when I started, within three or four years to win a \$50,000 race — with 12 horses in it and starting from the 12-hole with a 2-year-old filly — that was quite a deal."

Hie launched his career in the days before catch drivers, but he was always available to drive horses for other trainers and heading into this year's Kawartha Downs meet he sits at 2,512 wins and \$9.96 million in earnings as a driver. On the training front, he has tallied 589 wins and \$3.75 million in earnings.

"There wasn't very many people that just drove, well there wasn't really any. Brent Davies came from the west, and they had horses of their own, but Brent was what I call a catch driver. Brent drove a lot of horses for a lot of people," said Hie. "Everybody had their own stables, I mean big stables. Ronnie Feagan and Ron Waples and Keith Waples, it wasn't unusual for those people to have 30 horses in their stable, (and) they drove their own. I drove for people that I knew that didn't drive; sometimes it was people from home that came up to race in Toronto."

After purchasing his farm in Fraserville in 1974 Hie, and his late wife Marlene, decided to head south for the winter and spent almost two decades wintering at Pompano Park (read a story about one of Hie's 1977 Pompano stars here).

Harness Racing Update

"One year, we went down with one horse. I worked with Sandy Fisher and had one horse, but I came home with five," Hie said with a chuckle. "And sometimes I'd do the opposite, sometimes I'd go down with half a dozen and come home with three. I always said we should have kept a record and wrote the horses' names down that we had over the years, because I don't know how many it would be, but it would be a lot of horses."

Among the horses that would top that record are free-for-allers Timely Archer (Good Time) and Big Brother (Laverne Hanover). From modest beginnings, both horses would earn more than \$225,000 for owners the Van Stables.

"Big Brother had only ever raced once before we got him and he'd made a break and requalified. We bought him from Frank Conlin. He had brought him home from the states, and we bought him and he went from the maiden class to the free-for-all class, so that was pretty nice," said Hie. "And Timely Archer had been a decent horse and then got sore, and then we got him and he got to be a free-for-all pacer. So they were nice."

Hie also has a special fondness for trotters, among them homebred Hi Edith, who won four Ontario Sires Stakes events in her 2007 sophomore season, including a Grassroots Semifinal at Kawartha Downs. Hie and his late brother Roger bred the filly, with Roger handling training duties and Doug doing the driving. The daughter of Earl and Maritime Fidelity would go on to lifetime earnings of \$390,771.

"I've had times where I had a lot of trotters and I'd come out with a pacer and people would say, 'What are you doing with a pacer?' Well right now I've got one trotter. Out of 14 horses I've got one trotter, they're all pacers," said Hie.

"Now I'm going to try and qualify a couple of the pacers free-legged and I always say that's the next best thing to a trotter. I love trotters, I love working with them and trying to get them going, but it just works out whatever you have, that's what you wind up with."

While Hie does not have any standouts in his 2019 string, he does have a trio of 2-year-olds that have impressed him through the early stages of their development. Due to weather and a barn-wide bout with a virus all three will miss most, if not all, of their freshman season, but Hie is optimistic about 2020.

"Two of them are Sportswriters and the one is Hes Watching and I like them, I really like them, but it's going to be fall before they're ready, if we do continue on," said the horseman. "They're not going to be in the Sires Stakes this year, hopefully next year they'll be good enough, but this year is just going to be a summer project."

With 21 dates between May 11 and Sept. 28, Kawartha Downs is a summertime track and Hie said the environment reflects the area's easygoing lakeside vibe.

"There's a great customer base here in the summertime because they come from all over and they have cottages and trailers, it's just a great customer fan base," said Hie. "People love it. They love bringing their kids here, they're close to the horses, and they try to do a lot of things now to give the people a good time for the three hours they are here — as most tracks do, we're not alone there.

"There's been horsepeople in this area forever, from Morrow Park days and Orono Fairgrounds and everything. It's not like it was when it was 100 days a year, but it's still a social event for people to show up, whether they have horses or used to have horses. There's a lot of old timers that are pretty well out of the horses now, but they still come to the races on Saturday nights and they still like to socialise with everybody. It's just the way it's always been."

Hie's hints

Kawartha Downs is located in eastern Ontario, just south of Highway 115 on County Road 28, about 20 minutes north of the 401 and on the same longitude as Batavia, NY.

Hie said there are a wide variety of restaurants to choose from in Peterborough's bustling downtown, which is less than 10 minutes from the racetrack. Home to Trent University and Fleming College, Peterborough also caters to the summer cottagers, campers and canoers enjoying the dozens of fresh water lakes and the Trent-Severn Waterway.

If you have a few extra hours before Kawartha's 7 pm post time, Hie said the Peterborough Lift Locks are a must-see.

"If you want to see something spectacular, you have to go and see the lift locks," said the horseman. "I think the one that's here, don't quote me on this, but I think it's the biggest one as far as level-wise and the drop to it and everything. It's just amazing to have something like that that was built more than 120 years ago."











Strict handicapping points to the process of profiting

Last time out, Bettors Banquet (BB) defined handicapping (full story here) and yet, even those who have known the strict definition all along most likely continue to define it as amateurs have for decades — as the process of finding a winner, that is, a bet.

Stop it. Please follow the BB columns as they lead you to paths of profit probability, especially now, as the racing season becomes thick with races, stakes and overnights, that will undoubtedly offer great betting opportunities. Along with a developed talent for passing races that in the long run will do nothing to benefit your betting bankroll, you are crossing the threshold onto the professional platform.

Horseplayers are a stubborn lot. They are too loyal to minor elements that have brought them success (not necessarily profit) in the past. They become entrenched in their own devices, most of which are subjectively measured. One person weighs a handicapping factor heavily while another person feels it plays no role in which horse will win. The evidence each presents is skimpy, tenuous and bias to their experiences.

What else, then, can each do to actualize accuracy? They can handicap by strict definition, using the simple mathematics of gambling—percentages.

Here is the handicapping doctrine to institute change: Measure each horse's chance to win, then assigns odds (chances by percentage) for each horse in the field — which, remember, is the definition of "handicapping." That is the essential start to finding races worth playing and finding (not choosing) winners instead of picking them.

This is simpler than anyone truly cares to accept, because old habits die-hard. But die they must, and hopefully with no legacy. Get ready; it is time to handicap "by the book."

Step one: Learn the simple translation of odds to percentages. I have always been shocked that this level of arithmetic is not implicit among horseplayers. Ask any player to give you the percentage value of 3-1 or 6-1 or anything-to-one and do not hold your breath for a correct answer. So how does one learn these values? It is simple, because the World Wide Web is crawling with free

odds-to-percentage tables. Go to a search engine and enter "odds to percentage table." At Google alone there are 63 million links to easily readable tables. You will only need one to always have by your side when handicapping, at least until you can memorize it.

Step two: Forget about making any kind of wager. Betting on a race must be the last thing on your mind when you handicap correctly. Wagering will become a product of how you measure a race, as well as if you wager on it at all, and how you manage which bets you engage. Proper money management is an important topic we will thoroughly cover in future BBs.

Step three: Ignore the Morning Line odds. A track handicapper makes odds based upon how he or she thinks the public will support horses in the field. Never be influenced by such predictions — you must be assigning odds that are based upon your sole opinion, answering this question: If the race at hand were to take place 100 times, how many times would each horse win?

Step four: Go back to step one and referring to the odds-to-percentage table and your opinions on each horse's chance to win assign the percentage values of odds to each horse so the total equals one hundred per cent.

Reread the steps and study the odds-percentage table you got free from the Internet and get into this with enthusiasm. This will produce another moment that will change your history of betting on harness racing forever. This is an edge that will serve you greatly and place you among the smartest, most cunning horseplayers in the world and, most importantly, it is an edge that will lead you to choosing the best races to play and playing horses you may never have considered wagering upon using your old, tired methods—the ones you called handicapping.

Once you become acquainted with the odds-percentage table and approach each race with no intention of betting on it, (being extremely objective) you will be capable of measuring any size field to a one hundred percent total. You may have to calculate a second draft, adjusting some of your assigned odds, but it will not take as long as the time you may usually spend looking for a winner.

Because you are not looking for a winner.

The final draft of each race will be a personal product and when it supposes differently than your enemies (the betting public in any particular race) you will have the strongest weapon available to sensationalize upon the public's mistakes.

Tips on quick and accurate personal-odds writing using examples from recent races BB has addressed are coming up next time.

Melander hopes 'Cruzado' can cruise in Cutler

Marcus Melander is hoping Cruzado Dela Noche's seasonal debut in Saturday's (May 4) \$175,200 Arthur J. Cutler Memorial for older trotters at The Meadowlands follows the same script as the 7-year-old stallion's debut for his stable last fall. Simply put, with a win.

Cruzado Dela Noche captured the \$1 million Yonkers International Trot in October after returning to the U.S. from several years of campaigning in Europe. He arrived in Melander's barn during the summer, qualified twice in September, and then went out and won the International at odds of 30-1.

The horse heads to Saturday's Cutler also off two qualifiers at the Meadowlands, winning the first in 1:53.3 on April 13 and finishing third in 1:53.4 on April 27. He will start the Cutler, which attracted a 12-horse field and will be raced at 1-1/8 miles, from post No. 3 with Brian Sears in the sulky.

"We were very happy with both of his qualifiers," Melander said. "He won the International off two qualifiers, so I'm not too concerned that he hasn't raced. We've prepared him very well. We've got a good post and I'm excited. I think he is ready to roll."

Cruzado Dela Noche was a stakes winner at ages 2 and 3 while competing in North America for trainer Nancy Johansson. At 4, he was brought to Europe by owner Anders Ström (Courant A B) and raced for Melander's uncle, Stefan. He was a multiple Group 1 winner, including the 2017 Copenhagen Cup.

For his career, Cruzado Dela Noche has won 15 of 59 races and earned \$1.21 million. He is staked to the top races in North America this season, including the Breeders Crown, Maple Leaf Trot and Cashman Memorial.

"He's got a great attitude," Melander said. "He always gives everything he's got. He's a nice horse to be around, very easy to be around. He's a happy horse. I'm looking forward to the season to start."

The Cutler field also includes **Pinkman**, who won the 2015 Hambletonian on his way to being named Trotter of the Year; **Fiftydallarbill**, a Breeders Crown winner in 2017; **Top Flight Angel**, the 2017 Yonkers Trot winner; and Grand Circuit stakes winners such as **Will Take Charge** and **Yes Mickey**.

Guardian Angel As, who will start the Cutler from the second tier's post No. 11, is looking for his first major stakes victory. He finished second in last year's Allerage Open Trot, behind Homicide Hunter in his 1:48.4 world-record mile, and third in the Dayton Trotting Derby.

The 5-year-old stallion has won 16 of 40 career races and earned \$516,746 for owners ACL Stuteri AB and Kjell Johansson. He is trained by Anette Lorentzon and enters the Cutler off two qualifier wins, the most recent on April 24 in 1:54.2 at Miami Valley Raceway.

"We stretched him out a little bit," Lorentzon said. "He did it easy so we were happy with him. Training, he doesn't do more than you ask him to do. But he looks good. I'm just hoping we have some luck this year and he races good."

Racing begins at 7:15 p.m. (EDT) Saturday at the Meadowlands. The card also includes two divisions of the Graduate Series for 4-year-old pacers. For complete entries, click here.

Pennsylvania champ Osterc begins 2019 campaign in Dexter Cup

Osterc will take his first steps on the Hambletonian trail Saturday (May 4) when he faces seven foes in the \$118,950 Dexter Cup for 3-year-old male trotters at Freehold Raceway. Osterc, last season's Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion, is making his 2019 debut after sitting out last week's Dexter elimination thanks to a bye he received for being the field's top money-earner.

The Dexter Cup is the traditional first stakes race on the road to August's \$1 million Hambletonian Stakes, the sport's premier race for 3-year-old trotters. Osterc is among five Hambletonian-eligible trotters in the final, along with elimination winner Whirl Winds K, Cavill Hanover, HL Revadon, and Jason's Camden.

Osterc will start the Dexter Cup from post No. 6 on Freehold's half-mile oval. Yannick Gingras will drive the colt for trainer Per Engblom and breeder/owners Christina Takter and Goran Falk. Osterc qualified twice ahead of Saturday's start, winning in 1:55 on April 6 at the Meadowlands and finishing second behind pacer Albergo Hanover on April 19 at Freehold. Osterc was timed in 1:56.4.

"I was very pleased with that last qualifier," Engblom said. "He was plugs in and strong in that mile. I'm hoping he can go forward from there."

Osterc, a son of Cantab Hall-Oh Oh Hereshecomes, won five of seven races last year and earned \$226,401. Four of his victories came in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes series, including the final. The remaining win came in a conditioned race.

Engblom said he decided to accept the bye and skip the Dexter elimination in the hopes of keeping Osterc fresh through the year. He has the first leg of the sire stakes on May 11.

"This is just the beginning of the season," he said. "I'm hoping he is going to have a good season; I don't want to burn him out. We're going to start out in Pennsylvania and if he's good enough he has the Grand Circuit.

"I'm very happy with the way he came back. He's going to make some money this year and hopefully we can get a little bit of luck down the road too. He's coming back a little stronger than I anticipated. He doesn't have the greatest of gaits maybe, but he is very honest and gives you what he's got. His two qualifiers were very good. Let's hope that's a good sign for this week."

Whirl Winds K, who won the Dexter elimination by a nose over Cavill Hanover, will start the final from post four with George Brennan in the sulky for trainer Rich Gillock. The colt is owned by breeder Bob Key. He has won four of 13 career races and earned \$54,965. Two of the victories came last year when Whirl Winds K was limited to four starts.

"He had a few little issues and it just took a little while to get him squared away," Gillock said. "Before you knew it, it got to be October before he was able to keep going forward.

"He's a nice horse, he just has to get a little better so he can go and be competitive in the bigger races. Hopefully he will. He's got a great attitude about him, so that's a big factor."

Saturday's card at Freehold also includes the \$66,000 Lady Suffolk for 3-year-old female trotters. The race attracted a field of nine, including Hambletonian Oaks eligibles Rush Lane, Golden Tricks, and Presto Change O. The remainder of the group is Cardinale, Big Weezy, Magical Beliefs, Meadowbranch Vicki, Matterlei, and Atonement.

Racing begins at 12:30 p.m. (EDT) Saturday at Freehold. The Dexter Cup is race 10 and will be preceded by the Lady Suffolk. For the day's complete entries, click here.

Pappy Go Go ready for big test at Harrah's Philadelphia

After spending the early part of his racing career as a big fish in a small pond, Pappy Go Go is ready to head into open waters.

Pappy Go Go, a 5-year-old gelding who dominated in the Canadian Maritimes before arriving in the U.S. in 2018, will compete in Saturday's (May 4) first round of the Great Northeast Open Series for trotters at Harrah's Philadelphia. The Andrew Harris trainee is the 3-1 morning-line favorite in the race, which also includes 2018 Canadian Trotting Classic winner Crystal Fashion (7-2) and millionaire Melady's Monet (4-1).

A week ago, Pappy Go Go and driver George Napolitano Jr. won a conditioned race at Philly by 6-3/4 lengths in 1:52. The time equaled his career best, first established in a conditioned start on March 30 at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, and is the second fastest trotting time of the season.

Now he will go for the most lucrative purse of his career – \$30,000 – on Saturday.

"I'm in the same boat as everybody else; I don't know if he can go with these horses or not," Harris said. "I'm anticipating the race as much as anyone. I want to see what he is, see what he's got. I'm excited to see if he can handle it."

Pappy Go Go is a son of Tad The Stud out of Paging Willy. He was bred by Calgary's Bill Andrew, a recent inductee into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame whose family has long been involved in harness racing in the Maritimes.

As a 3-year-old Pappy Go Go was 13-for-13 racing in the Maritimes, where he won a total of 19 of 24 starts in his career. In January 2018, he sold for \$30,000 to Michael Goldberg's Chai-Five Racing and now competes for Michael Goldberg Racing LLC.

Goldberg gave Harris credit for picking out the horse.

"He was a proven winner," Goldberg said. "He didn't have the competition he has today, but he had beaten everything he had taken on before, and we liked the look of the horse.

"We love the horse. He behaves well, he's great to be around, and he continues to improve. This is going to be a big test for him, this is the deepest competition he's faced, but he's got two (1):52 miles this year and is sharp. We're excited about the race. We're going to see what we have the next couple weeks."

Goldberg, a psychologist who splits his time between

Florida and his native Massachusetts, got started in harness racing in 1992 when he bought into a \$2,500 claimer at Foxboro Raceway. His father and brother also got involved in the sport and were co-owners of 2004 Cutler Memorial winner War Paint.

"I took a little hiatus when I got married and had kids, but got back into it a few years ago," said Goldberg, who also has gotten involved in breeding and attaches the Boston-reference "Beantown" as a prefix to his horse's names.

Pappy Go Go has won nine of 40 races for Goldberg and Harris, earning \$109,273. He has hit the board in seven consecutive starts, winning two and finished second on four occasions.

"He was kind of in a rough spot last year as a 4-year-old racing aged horses, and he was also racing (a different level) of horses," Harris said. "It was just kind of a maturation process for him. Now he's developed into a nice horse. He had a few little issues last year with steering and now this year, I can't even tell you why, he's steering so much better." Harris was attracted to Pappy Go Go because of his ability to win races. He hopes to see it continue.

"I love a horse that loves to win," Harris said. "I don't care where you're at, when you're winning dominantly and you're the big fish in your small pond, there is always that chance to step up to the next level. He was worth the gamble just because of his winning nature."

Saturday's card at Philly also includes the \$30,000 first round of the Great Northeast Open Series for female pacers. Harris' Dont Think Twice A, co-owned by Goldberg, is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in the race, which also includes returning Dan Patch Award winner Kissin In The Sand for her debut at age 4.

Racing begins at 12:40 p.m. (EDT).



Canadian legend Dr. Ted Clarke of Grand River fame dead at 71

Dr. C. E. (Ted) Clarke passed away April 27 at St. Mary's Hospital in Kitchener, ON. He was 71.

A graduate of Ontario Veterinary College, Ted lived in Elmira, ON with his family for the past 47 years.

He co-owned Eldale Veterinary Clinic and was a practicing veterinarian while being heavily involved with the management of Elmira Raceway starting in the late 1980s, when he helped steer the track from financial ruin while he served as the horseperson's representative with the Ontario Harness Horse Association (OHHA).

In 1994, he helped establish the Ontario Teletheatre Network. He became the official GM of Elmira Raceway in 1995 (while still maintaining his veterinary practice) and pioneered a number of initiatives which solidified the track's finances and reputation. In 1998, Elmira Raceway became the first Ontario B-track to simulcast its races to a network of tracks and teletheatres throughout Canada and the U.S.

In 1998, Ted worked with local horsepeople to create the track's signature race, the (then) \$200,000 Battle Of Waterloo. The following year, Elmira Raceway was awarded the prestigious Lloyd Chisholm Achievement Award by the Standardbred Breeders' & Owners Association of Ontario, in recognition of its racing innovations for the betterment of the Ontario harness racing industry.

In 2002, Ted left veterinary medicine to assume a full-time role as the General Manager of the new Grand River Raceway in Elora, ON.

The creation of the track was his passion project.

Recognized by his peers as an innovator and highly regarded for his thoughtful insights, Ted's strong and steady leadership established Grand River Raceway's reputation as an award-winning racing and entertainment destination.

In 2014, Ted was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall Of Fame in the Builders' category. The honour

highlighted a career spent in the pursuit of the common good for horse racing.

In an article from TROT Magazine in 2014 (commemorating Ted's Hall Of Fame induction) long-time friend Dr. John Hayes (who attended Ontario Veterinary College with Clarke in the early '70s) is quoted: "That's the magic of Ted Clarke: patience to entertain dissenting views; a conciliatory demeanour that never offends; integrity of purpose; and intelligence to separate chicken soup and feathers."

After more than 30 years of tireless work in the Ontario harness racing industry, Ted retired from his post as the General Manager of Grand River Raceway in September, 2017.

Ted is survived by his wife Valorie; sister Christine and brother David; daughters Carrie and Amy; and granddaughters Morgan and Riley.

At Ted's request, cremation has taken place and there will be no funeral home visitation or service.

A celebration of life will be held on Wednesday, May 15 from 2:00 pm - 5:00 pm in the Lighthouse Restaurant at Grand River Raceway: 7445 Wellington County Rd. 21, Elora.

Somebeachsomewhere documentary screening to benefit Ontario Veterinary College Equine Research

The 2019 Eastlink Community TV documentary "Somebeachsomewhere: Horse of a Lifetime" makes its big screen debut Saturday, May 4, at the Mohawk Inn and Conference Centre, Milton, ON.

Last January, Somebeachsomewhere's battle with cancer left his connections no choice but to euthanize the 13-year-old stallion. In his memory, all funds raised at the film screening will be donated toward equine research at the Ontario Veterinary College, located in Guelph.

"We're grateful to USHWA Canada for this fundraiser on behalf of OVC equine research. We know from experience that many small donations can make a big difference," said OVC Dean Jeffrey Wichtel, who also shared an unexpected story about how small donations helped a four-legged celebrity of another species.

"When Esther the Wonder Pig needed a full-body scan, 11,000 fans got together this time last year and raised \$650,000 to purchase and donate to OVC the only CT scanner in the country large enough to scan pigs. We used it to find and remove Esther's tumours. But since then, we've found it really valuable in scanning standing horses and in our cancer research, helping us to do what we do best — save lives now and develop better ways to save lives in the future."

Keeping with the theme of small donations that create major impact, admission to the screening of "Somebeachsomewhere: Horse of a Lifetime" is \$10 at the door for adults, with free admission for children (must be accompanied by parent or guardian). Larger donations for OVC equine research will also be gratefully accepted at the event, which will include a silent auction for an original painting of Somebeachsomewhere by Ontario artist James McQuiggan, kindly contributed by OHHA general manager Brian Tropea.

Doors open at 3 pm for the 4 pm screening in the Conservation Hall, which will be followed by a question-and-answer session with a special guest (to be announced).

Harrah's Hoosier Park was formally awarded all 12 year-end championship races by the Hambletonian Society, which oversees the Breeders Crown Series.

This will be the second time that Harrah's Hoosier Park, home of harness racing in the state of Indiana, will serve as the event's host site.

Association I want to express how delighted we are to again partner in bringing the Breeders Crown back to Indiana," Indiana Standardbred Association president, Joe Putnam said. "This showcase of the best talent in harness racing saw Indiana shine on the national stage and we are hopeful to equal or surpass that fete in 2020."

"Hoosier Park hosted one of our most successful Breeders Crown events in 2017 and we are thrilled they are back in host track rotation again in 2020," said Hambletonian Society president John Campbell.

"We look forward to working with Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino and the Indiana Standardbred Association in raising the bar on hospitality, championship racing and showcasing another world class event."

Harrah's Hoosier Park hosted Indiana's debut of the Breeders Crown in October of 2017, creating a week-long Festival that culminated in two nights of Breeders Crown finals. More than \$4 million was bet on the events, with a track lifetime record of \$2.1 million wagered in one single night.

"Record wagering handles, a sold-out grandstand, entrants and winners from all over North America, a first class staff and tremendous economic impact for the Anderson community all made the decision to return to Hoosier an easy one," said Campbell. "The Society is grateful and acknowledges the efforts of everyone involved in the Standardbred industry in Indiana who worked hard to make their state synonymous with world class racing."

In addition to record-setting handle at Harrah's Hoosier Park's inaugural Breeders Crown, a tremendous showing was made by local representatives, who took home three of the 12 crystal Crown trophies.

"Dan Patch Horse of the Year Award winners Hannelore Hanover and Always B Miki are just two Indiana-bred performers who have received accolades at the highest level and we look forward to providing the stage again in 2020," added Campbell.

The 35-year-old series has typically crowned champions in every division for trotters and pacers and has been the deciding factor in Horse of the Year honors since 1984. More than \$250 million in purse money has been disbursed over 406 events. Originally conceived and executed as a traveling series, the Crown has been contested at racetracks across North America and been raced as a single night as well as multiple night events.


Much like the Super Bowl, the season-culminating Breeders Crown series does not have a fixed venue. The Breeders Crown races were held at The Mohegan Sun Pocono Downs in Pennsylvania in 2018 and will be hosted at Woodbine Mohawk Park in Canada in 2019 before heading to Harrah's Hoosier Park in 2020.

"We look forward to working with the Hambletonian Society and the Indiana Standardbred Association in making next year's event our biggest and best championship racing event yet."

Holloway records 1,000th training win

Trainer Joe Holloway, part of the Hall Of Fame incoming class in July at Goshen, got an early distinction in this memorable year by posting, according to USTA records, the 1,000th training victory "of his second career" when the royally-bred Voyager broke his maiden in an impressive 1:52.2 on Wednesday afternoon at Harrah's Philadelphia.

Holloway started in the harness racing business when he was an altar boy for Father Francis Tierney, in Delaware, working as a groom after the priest decided to take up a field in which many of his parishioners participated. Holloway was already an established record-maker in training partnership with stable manager David Rovine, having set a Meadowlands-then-record 106 victories in 1987 – well before this count to 1,000 started, as the USTA records begin in 1991.

Plenty of star power in Saturday's preferred at Mohawk

Stakes season at Woodbine Mohawk Park is just around the corner and racing fans will get an opportunity to whet their appetite with this Saturday's edition of the \$34,000 Preferred Pace.

Millionaire pacer Sintra (PP5, Jody Jamieson) increased his current win streak to six with an impressive 1:50.1 score in last week's Preferred, his first start since late-February. The 6-year-old gelding has been rolling in the preferred this season, but with a new month comes new challengers.

Stars Jimmy Freight, last year's O'Brien Award winner, and Dr J Hanover, the fastest Standardbred in Canadian racing history, join Sintra and four other rivals to make up this week's edition of the \$34,000 preferred.

Richard Moreau trainee Jimmy Freight (PP1, Louis Philippe Roy) will be making his 4-year-old debut in Saturday's contest and comes in off a sharp 1:52.4 qualifying effort last Thursday. The Ontario Sires Stakes champion is prepping for next weekend's Confederation Cup eliminations.

Jimmy Freight is no stranger to facing older company, having faced aged competitors on multiple occasions last season. The son of Sportswriter grabbed headlines with a third-place effort in last year's Mohawk Gold Cup, which was part of an incredible season that saw him win 11 of 21 starts and earn \$834,489 for owner Adriano Sorella.

Dr J Hanover (PP2, Doug McNair) comes to town after battling in the Levy Series at Yonkers Raceway. The Tony Alagna trainee most recently captured a \$50,000 Levy Eligible contest on April 20 for his first win in seven starts this season.

Now 6, Dr J Hanover scored six wins and made \$227,980 in 23 starts last season, which included appearances in the Canadian Pacing Derby and TVG Open. He races for owners Brad Grant, Robert LeBlanc, Steven Wienick and ISFT.

Saturday's preferred also includes recent winners Traceur Hanover (PP3, Chris Christoforou) and Physicallyinclined (PP7, Jonathan Drury). The field is rounded out by Go West Go Fast (PP4, Sylvain Filion) and P L Jackson (Travis Cullen).

Dover Dony wins Weiss

Simon Allard won his third of the four \$30,000 Bobby Weiss Series Championships conducted this spring at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, taking Monday's rich finale for trotting males with the 1:54 winner Dover Dony.

70-1 shot Chapter And Ruth (trained by Rene Allard, who had combined with his brother Simon on their two earlier Weiss wins) shot out from PP9 right to the top for driver Tom Jackson, looping the winning son of Andover Hall, who eventually worked his way to the top before the :27.4 opener. Allard gave his charge a :57.1 breather to the half, then sent the 6-5 second choice through a :27.3 third quarter to try to put separation between himself and 3-5 favorite My Lindy Winner, who was looking for a Weiss sweep.

My Lindy Winner came wide off cover late on the final turn for driver Jim Morrill Jr., and Chapter And Ruth popped out from the pocket, but Dover Dony had enough to maintain a length margin to the finish while lowering his mark 3 2/5 seconds. Chapter And Ruth, who had a Weiss prelim win (which ironically is more than the winner could say) showed determination to take second, a neck ahead of My Lindy Winner, who had been undefeated in six seasonal starts. Dover Dony had a 37-2-10-10 record before this final, but he surely picked a good time to become more photogenic for trainer Jordan Derue and owner Anthony Ciuffetelli.

In the \$15,000 Weiss consolation for the male trotting set, the sophomore Yankee Glide gelding Raceace set a North American season's record of 1:54.3 for his division while lowering his mark nearly three seconds. Matt Kakaley put his horse on the lead in his fourth lifetime start, and the even money favorite stepped home in :56.1 - :27.4 to keep 6-5 shot Omaha Omaha away by a head at the wire for trainer Nifty Norman and the All Laid Out Stable Inc.

Warrawee Ubeaut debuts in PASS today in Philly

Warrawee Ubeaut, the filly who became the fastest 2-year-old of all time when she won in 1:48.3 en route to her 2018 divisional championship, makes her seasonal debut today at Harrah's Philadelphia in what will also be the first 2019 racing in the rich Pennsylvania Sire Stakes program. There will be two \$83,240 divisions of Sire Stakes three-year-old pacing fillies, while their Stallion Series counterparts will contest \$20,000 in each of five divisions.

The Sweet Lou filly Warrawee Ubeaut, to start from post seven in her Sire Stakes section for driver Yannick Gingras and the ownership of Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Bruscemi LLC, Phil Collura, and J&T Silva- Purnel & Libby, is one of six fillies trainer Ron Burke has entered in the Sire Stakes, and he'll have three going in each division. Warrawee Ubeaut, who also was the richest freshman in 2018 North American harness racing with \$646,995 in earnings, won her Breeders Crown event last year, one of her seven victories on the campaign; another was the historic world record at Lexington, where she came home in :53.2. Warrawee Ubeaut has had two qualifying preps at The Meadowlands for her sophomore campaign, both times winning in 1:53.2.

The champion's main rival in this event may be the Somebeachsomewhere filly Stonebridge Soul, who won her last two starts as a freshman in stakes company, then returned last week for trainer Chris Ryder and driver Dexter Dunn by winning at Philly in 1:53.1, with twin :27.3s coming home. Taking a shot at "the big girls" is another daughter of Somebeachsomewhere, Trillions Hanover, the winner of her 2018 Stallion Series Championship and also victorious in her

first start of the year in 1:52.3 at The Meadowlands for trainer Tom Fanning.

In the second Sire Stakes division, starting from the rail will be Sylph Hanover, another Burke trainee who was a 13-1 upset winner in her Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Championship last season in 1:51.4. Matt Kakaley is the regular driver of the Somebeachsomewhere filly for Burke Racing LLC, William Switala, James Martin, and Joseph Critelli, and he was in the sulky when "Sylph" added the Matron Pace to her list of credits towards the end of her two-year-old campaign.

Sylph Hanover faces no fewer than four horses coming off of a victory. Three of them are undefeated in their 2019 campaigns; the other, Pretty N Fast, added her third straight victory in a late-closing final at The Meadows last time, and she also hails from the productive Burke barn.

The Sire Stakes events will go in races eight and 12; the five Stallion Series events will face the gate in races three, seven, nine, 11, and 13. Though currently in the lower division of the program, the Stallion Series fillies have already won 24 races among them this year, and some are only now finding their top form.

Post time for today's card at Philly is 12:25. There will be live racing on both Saturday and Sunday at 12:40; the Saturday card is a special Kentucky Derby Day card that will feature opening round action of the 2019 Great Northeast Open Series.

Dealer's Table, the 7-5 favorite who was impossible to rate in defeat last week, again was too hot on the front end (hitting three-quarters in 1:21.1), enabling Miller to vacate the pocket - a position he earned by leaving the gate at the start from post eight - and roll by the leader before holding off a determined Stone Hanover, who missed by a big nose after closing well late. World On Edge was third.

Prince Of Tides, a gelded son of Somebeachsomewhere—Tug River Princess who is trained by Ross Croghan, returned \$15.80 as the third choice on the tote board.

Pinkman (\$5.20 to win as the favorite), the 2015
Hambletonian champion and lifetime earner of better than
\$2.7 million, was victorious in the first leg of the Mr
Muscleman for open trotters in 1:52.4 while Highalator
(\$5.40 as the public choice) scored in the opening leg of the
Golden Receiver for open pacers, stopping the clock in 2:03.4
for the added distance of a mile and an eighth. Highalator
has won three of four starts at the Big M this year.
