Eldorado Scioto Downs opens new grandstand to launch 64th season

The 30,000-square foot structure headlines \$30 million in improvements.

In maybe the most anticipated opening day in Eldorado Scioto Downs history, the south Columbus track looks to regain its position as "Ohio's Showplace of Racing" when it opens its 64th year of racing on Thursday (May 11).

Gone is the iconic grandstand that was condemned in 2017. The futuristic plant has been replaced with a brand new 30,000-square foot facility with 700+ stadium seats, 10 private box

seat areas, two VIP rooms and a picnic area on the north end of the building.

Noticeable improvements were also made in the existing clubhouse dining room, the patio area and the winner's circle.

In total, the improvements will run close to \$30 million, showing Eldorado Scioto Downs' commitment to the future of the sport.

"It was a lot of hard work and a lot of long hours," said Jason Roth, Scioto Downs director of racing. "We are extremely proud of what we have here and for the future of this track."

In 1958, Charlie Hill acted on his dream to build a state-of-the-art track to replace the aged Hilliard Raceway, the site of the current Franklin County Fairgrounds.

Hill broke ground on his \$3 million, 140-acre dream facility with an ambitious goal of having it ready for a summer 1959 meet. A cold, wet winter caused construction delays, pushing the inaugural Scioto Downs opening to the fall.

Construction of the new grandstand took nearly one year to be completed. Also, in a twist of fate, concrete from the original grandstand was crushed down and was used as backfill for the new plant.

The south Columbus oval will have a 3:15 p.m. post time on Tuesdays and Wednesdays and a 5:50 p.m. first post on Thursday through Saturday.

“We gave the post time change plenty of thought,” Roth said. “The horsemen love the earlier posts because they can train in the morning, race in the afternoon and be home at a decent hour. However, our ultimate goal is to bring back the fans to the track, so the evening post will accommodate that.”

Trainer Virgil Morgan Jr. is looking to add to his nearly three-decade stranglehold as the leading conditioner at Scioto Downs. Morgan, whose streak started in 1996, was named to the Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 2021 and has over 7,200 career wins.

What isn't certain is who the top reinsman at Scioto Downs may be, as the last five southern Ohio meets have been won by five different drivers: Tyler Smith (2021, Dayton Raceway), Brett Miller (2022, Miami Valley), Chris Page (2022, Scioto Downs), Jeremy Smith (2022, Dayton Raceway) and Trace Tetrick (2023, Miami Valley). All but Tetrick are expected to spend a majority of their time at Scioto Downs this summer.

The 2023 Scioto Downs stakes calendar is packed and prosperous.

The fourth edition of the \$600,000 (est.) Next Generation events for 2-year-olds will take place on Saturday, July 1, the \$200,000 (est.) #Sendit and Cleopatra invitationals for aged pacers are carded for July 29, and the \$1 million (est.) Ohio State Fair Stakes will be contested from Aug. 3 - 5.

The \$3.7 million (est.) Ohio Super Night will return to Scioto Downs on Saturday, Sept. 9 with the Ohio Sires Stake Finals and Consolations, the Jim Ewart Memorial and the Charlie Hill

Memorial: making the card a potential 18-race marathon with a special 5:00 p.m. post.

Scioto Downs is catering to the wagering public with free past performance programs each day and race replays on their website (www.caesars.com/scioto-downs).

The 90-date meet will conclude on Saturday, Sept. 16.

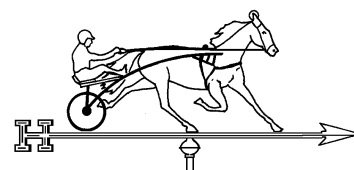

Likely Elitloppet favorite San Moteur dominated Saturday's Paralympiatravet

San Moteur (Panne de Moteur), the probable favorite in this year's Elitloppet, was the heavy choice in the \$295,000 Paralympiatravet final at Åby racetrack on Saturday (May 6) afternoon.

When driver Björn Goop hit the lead a half mile into the race, it was basically over.

Mister Hercules was pushed to the lead after 500 meters and Goop was quick to answer a few hundred meters later. When San Moteur hit the lead, the field was set.

San Moteur was challenged by a strong Hades de Vandel throughout the last turn, but when Goop asked for the extra gear in San Moteur, the duo flew away from the rest of the field.

San Moteur solidified his position as one of the best older trotters in Europe and he will enter the Elitloppet with a lot of expectations from the fans.

Hades de Vandel was a strong runner up while Rackham was third. The mile rate for San Moteur was 1:54 over 1.3 miles.

JOVIALITY WINS FIRST EUROPEAN TROPHY

Heavy favorite **Joviality** (Chapter Seven) was superior against her opponents when the \$195,000 Drottningpokalen for 4-year-old mares was held at Åby racetrack on Saturday (May 6) afternoon.

Erik Adielsson noted soon after the starting car accelerated that he couldn't reach the front position with Joviality, so he played it safe and waited to connect to leader Riverdale Z's outside with a kilometer to go in the 1.3-mile-long race.

Joviality's previous merits and experience obviously played their part when the field was going into the last turn. When Adielsson pushed on Joviality's power button, she immediately established a two-to-three-length advantage.

Sabine Kagebrant trains Joviality and it was a big day for her. "Joviality was just... the best today and it's very inspiring to have a horse like her in the stable," said Kagebrant.

Joviality will be a fresh contribution to stakes races in Sweden later on this season and she will be the mare to hunt when the remaining group 1-races are held.

The mile rate for the winner was 1:56.3. Kayla Westwood finished strongly as runner up ahead of O'Mara Zon.

Courant Stable had a great day at Åby racetrack.

Jörgen Westholm trains their 5-year-old mare **Imhatra Am** (Muscle Hill) who impressed in a safe wire-to-wire win in the \$49,000 Lovely Godivas Minne over 1.3 miles. Driver Mats E Djuse hit the lead and was determined to stay in that position when outside horses tried to reach the front. The race was kept in high pace and first choice Clarissa couldn't challenge the leader, who left the opponents far behind at the top of the stretch. Imhatra Am flew to victory in a mile rate of 1:55.2.

Brodde climbed high on the career ladder during the fall of 2022 after winning the Breeders Crown for 3-year-olds in November. During the winter, the son of Bold Eagle seems to have developed every part that's needed to become an accomplished trotter.

From post 1 behind the car, Untersteiner had a clear plan when the gate left the field. The front position was taken without any problems and when Untersteiner was allowed to slow down the pace before the last lap, the opponents never got close in the finish.

Tetrick Wania held strong in second after a first over trip, while Bedazzled Sox claimed the bronze medal from the pocket.

Dancer Brodde won in a mile rate of 1:55.2 over 1.3 miles.

Kentucky River (Father Patrick) had a strong wire-to-wire effort in the \$49,000 Lyon Grand Prix over 1.6 miles. Per Nordström's trotter had to defend himself from attacks throughout the race, but despite high pace, Kentucky River sprinted to a safe win in a strong mile rate of 1:56.1 over 1.6 miles.

NEW FRENCH NAME ADDED TO THE ELITLOPPET FIELD

French-bred Hohneck is ready for the Elitloppet at Solvalla on May 28.

Solvalla's sports general Anders Malmrot invited the Philippe Allaire-trained 6-year-old Royal Dream son to the Elitloppet on Saturday (May 6). Nine horses are now invited to the Elitloppet, of which four are French-bred and trained.

Much less chaotic

Bruce Richardson's Ontario Sired Spring Series champ Like Chaos is moving forward.

On April 22, a very good 3-year-old trotter captured the \$45,500 Ontario Sired Spring Series final over a "good" racing surface at Woodbine Mohawk Park (WMP). Like Chaos (Looklikeeachpndale—Misty Breeze) won the preliminary leg by four open lengths on April 7, with co-owner/trainer Bruce Richardson in the sulky. The 1:58 victory came five days after a gate-to-wire romp at Flamboro Downs, when the gelding was a widening 10 ½ lengths ahead of next-best Creed Hanover at the finish in the 2:00 mile. It was Canada's co-fastest mile by a 3-year-old male trotter on a half-mile track this year.

“He was really green as a 2-year-old. He'd go a quarter and then he'd let up on you. He'd just fold right up on you. He didn't know enough to carry the speed for the whole mile, but now he's starting to get it figured out. He's figured out what he's supposed to do, I guess.”

As of May 5, Like Chaos (3, 1:57.2s; \$44,468) had not resurfaced after his lifetime-best victory. Richardson, reached at his home in Fergus, ON, said that the black licorice-loving gelding was just taking a short but well-earned vacation. The trotter, bred by Larry R. Miller of Sugarcreek, OH, had already won back his price as a yearling and then some.

"I bought [Like Chaos] out of Harrisburg. I saw that he was a Looklikeeachpndale. I bred my mare to Looklikeeachpndale, so I just wanted to take a look at him. They were having trouble getting a bid on him, so I bought him," Richardson said with a laugh. "He had OCD chips taken out of his hocks or something. I think his hocks were still swollen a little bit, because people stayed away from him because of that." Richardson's \$9,000 bargain yearling is co-owned with his friend Joseph Coffey of Orangeville, ON.

The gelding's improvement at age 3 comes after an abbreviated 2-year-old season in which he went winless.

"[Like Chaos] always trained down good, but then, as a 2-year-old, he got a little bit sick, and I think I raced him one start at Mohawk when he was not quite ready yet," Richardson said. "That kind of set him back a little bit. So, once I turned him out and brought him back this year, he made a break on me in one of his first starts this year. Since then, he's kind of come right around."

As Like Chaos learned his job, he made Richardson's easier.

"He was really green as a 2-year-old," he said. "He'd go a quarter and then he'd let up on you. He'd just fold right up on you. He didn't know enough to carry the speed for the whole mile, but now he's starting to get it figured out. He's figured out what he's supposed to do, I guess."

The Ontario Sired Series at WMP was a perfect fit for the improving sophomore.

"The reason I put him in the series was because he'd race against all Ontario-sired horses," Richardson said. "We just put him in there to get some starts into him. He's come right around."

Trevor Henry took the lines in Like Chaos' last two starts in Campbellville.

"I usually drive my own at Mohawk, but I was going to Florida for an old-timers' hockey tournament," Richardson said. "That's why I put Trevor down, because I wasn't going to be around. The first time Trevor drove him [April 14, in the second leg of the series], they went in 1:55. He trotted in 1:55.4 and came home a nice quarter in :27.2. In the final he just got a perfect trip: He followed Jody [Jamieson, driving 1-2 favorite Devils Arch] second over and when he moved, [Like Chaos] went right on by him."

As for where the WMP Ontario Sired Spring Series champ might show up next, Richardson said there are plans for him to compete at The Raceway at Western Fair.

"I gave him a week after that [Ontario Sired] series, because he'd gone five weeks in a row," he said. "Now he's got a series coming up in London, the City of London Series. It's for non-winners of \$10,000 as of Feb. 1. He hadn't gotten rolling yet, so he still fits that class. I think it will be two or three easy starts for him before the [Ontario] Sires Stakes gets fired up. I'll probably drive him in London."

Like Chaos is ultimately being pointed toward the Ontario Sires Stakes and isn't eligible to Grand Circuit events at Mohawk.

"That's our game plan," Richardson said. "He's not paid up into any of that. We'll probably start in the Grassroots; see how he turns out there first."

Richardson said he usually drives his own stock at Mohawk because one of the biggest differences between that and driving at Flamboro and Western Fair comes down to purses.

"You just go for that much more money, so it's nicer when you get a check," he said.

He's a believer in stallion Lookslikeeachpndale and not just because of Like Chaos' recent success.

"I have a 2-year-old trotting filly [No One] out of a nice mare I have called Stormont Kate [4, 1:53.3s; \$270,547]," said Richardson, who also owns the yearling full brother, named Somebody.

Richardson's experience has helped offset the inexperience of Like Chaos at just the right time for the 2023 stakes season.

"I started driving in 1990. I've been cleaning out stalls since public school, I know that," he said with a laugh, adding that he likes what he currently sees in Like Chaos.

"He's pretty honest right now," he said. "He hasn't been making breaks. He just wants to go forward, I guess."

The enduring eloquence of Stan Bergstein, Part 2

There is a moment in the movie *Ordinary People* when Calvin Jarrett says to his son, "Don't admire people too much. They'll disappoint you sometimes." I knew immediately that is what Stan Bergstein meant when he said, "Never love a horse." It was the single most important piece of advice I received during my early seasons learning about harness racing and it proved itself an unvaried truth long before I predicted Western Hanover would lose the 1992 Little Brown Jug.

I spent more time with Mr. Bergstein that day in Ohio and the overwhelming love for Western Hanover made me happy I went public with a Bergstein audience listening. I did not even love the two pacers I mentioned for an upset and when Direct Flight did not make the final, I was left to defend my forecast with Fake Left.

"Really?" said a tall man standing next to me in the infield.

"Absolutely," I said and apologized for not knowing him.

"I'm Governor Jim Edgar," he said, "of Illinois."

"Yes, sir, nice to meet you. I'm aware of your support for the standardbred industry." I introduced myself as an editor for TIMES: in harness.

"You like Fake Left that much?" he said.

"Governor, I don't like Fake Left at all but I know I don't like Western Hanover. I'm so sure he's going to disappoint the majority of bettors that I tried to bet my life on it with a fellow journalist."

"That Fake Left will win?"

"No, that Western Hanover will lose."

"That's a significant bet, all right."

"He brushed me off but I'll be satisfied enough to know he lost money and no love was lost between me and Western Hanover."

Later, I sat squashed in the confined backseat of David Dolezal's Porsche so I could ride back to our hotel with Mr. Bergstein in the passenger seat where he commended me for my lack of loving a horse.

Back in Pennsylvania, I became Stan Bergstein's editor for his column ran in TIMES: I was aware of his unswerving confidence in the texts he delivered and how he revolted if any changes were made, especially without his consent. I also knew not to admire him too much because "he could disappoint me sometimes" in our editorial relationship. We

became comfortable with our writer-editor relationship and one day he called me his "favorite editor." That was all the more meaningful than admiration could satisfy.

Then there was this time in Florida...

I was in a tavern with the U.S. Harness Writers Association (USHWA) group. I was in town to attend the USHWA-members dinner at Pompano Park. The first night in Miami we were all in a tavern. I made points as a new member of the standardbred writers group by correctly answering Jerry Connor's potent trivia question, "What is the first line in the movie *Citizen Kane*?"

Though not on my schedule, I decided to attend the "of-the-year" awards, but there was a problem; the dinner/ceremony had a

formal-dress policy and I did not pack for such an occasion. Mr. Bergstein would not approve of my appearance if I did not meet the clothing requirements. However, he said I could fake it with any kind of black pants, a white shirt and tie and a dark jacket.

“You’ll be the only one in disguise,” Mr. Bergstein said.

He handed me over to his trusty Harness Tracks of America executives Ray Gomez and Chris McErlean and with their help we used a pair of my tight black jeans and a borrowed casual white shirt and tie and sports jacket as my formal disguise. When Mr. Bergstein came to our table, he gave me one of those crooked smiles.

“Don’t stand on my account,” he said.

I could hardly stand at all because my poor costume would give me away from any angle. Mr. Bergstein understood. After all, he made it possible when all he had to do was deny my appearance all together. (I like to think he got a laugh out of it, too).

I returned to Pennsylvania with a number of industry stories as a part of a new community of professionals and worked with Mr. Bergstein on his column titled “Loose Lines” until the publication’s collapse in the early 2000s.

Oddly enough, it was not until Mr. Bergstein’s passing in 2011 that I researched his professional history. I was not amazed at his lucrative contributions to the horse racing industry over decades; for me they were obvious. What was most important to me was the value of his education long before and since I became a member of the standardbred community.

My respect overruled my admiration and after all, it was two decades later that I did not fall in love with Bulldog Hanover and was able to publicly support and cash a ticket on Desperate Man in the 2021 North America Cup final.

The breakup

When explaining harness racing to newcomers, keep it simple and less is more.

When Amanda Montclair entered Starbucks, customers shifted their eyes away from their double café lattes and Fear Street Frappes. The tall, striking woman in her orange and white jogging suit, with blonde hair pulled back into a tight ponytail, appeared like a multitasking Hallmark movie mother of teenagers who had just dropped them off for private tennis lessons. Not even close.

Amanda is unmarried with no children, works as a corporate bankruptcy analyst and parked her beloved Porsche turbo in front of the outdoor dining patio. She gave me a finger wave, crossed the restaurant like a movie star and planted a quick peck on my cheek. She settled in the chair across from me and reached across the tabletop to take my hands.

Amanda: "Trey, we need to talk."

Trey: "Uh, oh."

Amanda: "We both know this is not working."

Trey: "True."

Amanda: "We've both known it for a long time."

Trey: "How long?"

Amanda: "It's been a year without many sparks."

Trey: "Don't say: it's not your fault."

Amanda: "Oh, it's your fault. It's your hobby. I know it means a lot to you and you tried desperately to get me involved, but it's just not happening."

Trey: "You're not the first to bail. You're about the 19th. I've tried men, women, young, old and everything in between. Getting anyone involved in the sport is an impossible dream."

Amanda (sweetly): "I'm not your Dulcinea."

Trey (sighs): "If finding new harness racing fans was my job, I'd be sleeping in my car."

Amanda: "Your sport is so, so slow."

Trey: "Not when you get into it."

Amanda: "Do this math for our trudging filly. The lovely Miss Match raced three times. Each race was two minutes, which worked out to six minutes of action in one year and even then, I was not quite sure what I was watching."

Trey: "Technically, she is a 'trotting' filly and her three races were each about two minutes and 10 seconds, so you had action for six and a half minutes, but I get your drift."

Amanda: "Would you like a few suggestions for your next recruitment effort?"

Trey: "Suggestions or therapy? I need help."

Amanda: "Compression."

Trey: "Like CPR?"

Amanda (smiles): "Compression of time and information."

Trey: "Okay, I get the time compression. I've thought about that and considered bringing in a newbie just before qualifying. What's the volume angle?"

Amanda: "Your sport has too much going on to get newbie brains around. Colt, gelding, ridgling, mare, filly, trotter, pacer, different ages, racetracks, stakes races and non-stakes races. That's too much information for a person new to your sport."

Trey (nodding): "Not to mention pedigrees, Grand Circuit racing, overnight racing, different-sized tracks, wagering and racing strategy."

Amanda: "Exactly, skip that stuff. All that information is confusing. Unclutter new minds. Don't even bother us until racing. Then, when you introduce the horse to us, silo and mask as much as possible."

Trey: "Silo and Mask? Isn't that a WWE tag team?"

Amanda: "Pull the young racehorse out of the stall and explain to the newbie that this is a 2-year-old girl [filly] trotting horse. She will only race against 2-year-old trotting girls [fillies]. Remove every other age, sex and gait of racehorses. They can fall off the earth as far as we are concerned."

Trey: "A tad harsh, but..."

Amanda: "To further declutter, text your next new prospect a list of quantified 2-year-old trotting fillies."

Trey: "Qualified, it's qualified."

Amanda: "Oh, anyway, this list of horses contains the names of the only horses the person needs to care about. We owners are all in the same boat, the same small tribe, the same herd of competitors. Tell the new person that last week, we proved we are fast enough to compete with the others in our tribe who made it to the races. We want to be one of the better horses in our tribe and update the list every week."

Trey: "Keep it simple."

Amanda: "The simpler, the better. If you had shown me just one horse and her competitors last summer, maybe your sport would have stuck."

Trey (excited): "If I introduced a horse that was part of a smaller sires' stakes program, like Minnesota, Virginia, or Kentucky, the pool of competitors would be smaller. Heck, perhaps only a half dozen."

Amanda: "An excellent idea. A small state racing program with only a handful of competitors does not feel daunting to people who know little about your little world. Maybe I could have wrapped my mind around things and caught a bit of your fever. Oh and it would help if you had been more proactive."

Trey: "Proactive?"

Amanda: "You notified me when the horse raced and took me to a fair race. That's insufficient. It would help if you took me to the race or at least been on a Zoom call, explaining what is happening slowly and carefully. A leader needs to lead, not just send out invitations. Compress time, mask and silo information. Be more hands-on. If you hook someone, they have forever to fill in the blanks."

Trey: "You used the terms maybe and perhaps, so does this suggest you are open to another lap around the harness racing track?"

Amanda: "No, we're finished. I'm seeing someone else; he's introducing me to Bocce Ball. It's faster, easier to understand and more economical."

Trey: "I understand. So we are breaking up or whatever. Oh well, we will always have Paris, well not Paris, but the Dover Fairgrounds."

Amanda (sigh): "Yeah, all two minutes and ten seconds."

Dr. Nena Winand is a lifelong equine fanatic

I have never met Dr. Nena Winand. However, we have “known” each other for the last few years through the sometimes-demonic entity called Facebook. Demonic, because sometimes it seems like Facebook insidiously takes over much of one’s being and causes one to spend much more time on it than is good for one’s well-being. Through this acquaintanceship, I have become certain that Winand has been stricken with the malady that I call equine fanaticism: more distinctly fanaticism of the harness horse variety.

How did this come to pass? Let’s start at the beginning.

Winand was born and raised in the then small town of State College, PA, home to the main campus of Penn State University. She does not come from a horse racing background. She was smitten with the love of horses from the very first time she was around them, in her case being exposed to the Percherons then in residence on the school’s campus. It was at the age of 13 that Winand decided that she wanted to spend her life being involved with large animals: more specifically with horses. She attended her hometown school, graduating with degrees in Animal Science and Veterinary Science from Penn State. She then went to Iowa State where she pursued research in virology.

She became a pathology resident and later a faculty member at Cornell University where she taught for the next 25 years.

In the interim, she and her husband Greg became the owners of a 17-acre farm in Groton, NY, only a short jaunt from Cornell.

It was perhaps through Facebook that she became enamored with harness racing. Two of her earliest friends on Facebook were Iowa harness racing devotees Royal and Barbara Roland. She began to follow the Iowa fair circuit and became intrigued with the sport. The Rolands had planned to come east to attend the Morrisville yearling sale. They made arrangements to meet Nena there.

It was at the same sale, two years later, where Nena made her first harness horse purchase. She had been wanting to get involved for some time. The prevailing advice had always been that if one were going to become involved in the sport, the best

way to begin would be to get involved with older horses who were already racing.

Not one to take good advice, Nena met Charlie Longo, founding member of Winners Circle Racing partnership group and with them became part-owner of the yearling filly Summer Storm. Summer Storm turned out to be an adequate first purchase. She took a trotting record of 1:56.3 and has earned over \$36,000. Now 5, she is still racing, but hasn’t hit her best form yet this year.

Summer Storm was Nena’s first purchase, but far from her last. She has since bought into several more. At present she has seven in training and boards six at her farm.

Let’s begin with your six residents at the home farm, specifically Lady Mattgalane.

“You might say that I am horse poor and you would undoubtedly be right. They are not all harness horses. We have two retirees, the now 15-year-old gelding Archangel Hanover, the 21-year-old Winners Only and the pride of the group, 19-year-old Lady Mattgalane. There was quite a circuitous route leading to my becoming the owner of Lady Mattgalane. She was initially bred and raised by Hanover Shoe Farms. She was purchased by Perretti Farms and Clay Horner for \$50,000 at the 2005 New Jersey Classic yearling sale. She turned out to be a fortuitous purchase becoming a Grand Circuit Stakes winner with earnings of \$378,257. After her racing days were over, she entered the Perretti Farms broodmare band. One might be inclined to say that, at least initially, she was a disappointment as a broodmare. Her first six foals did little of consequence.

“It was only after she was switched from Rocknroll Hanover to Bettors Delight that she in effect hit paydirt. Her seventh foal, Velocity Lady, did not race until she was 4, but then took off. She is now racing in Ohio. She has a record of 1.49.4f and has earned in excess of \$220,000. Lady Mattgalane was part of the 2013 dispersal of Perretti Farms and was purchased by Mark Evers. She was subsequently sold to the Amish for whom she toiled on the road and became a prospective broodmare. She became lame and was thought to be barren when I purchased her from a New York horse dealer for \$700 to prevent her from going through a low-end auction.

“The so-called barren mare turned out to be in foal to an unknown Percheron stallion. On August 1, 2021 she gave birth to a big strapping colt who I named Cantore. Cantore is about to be shipped to R.J. Bradford at Lone Birch Stables who will train him as a riding horse. Initially, I had no plans to breed Lady Mattgalane. The plan was to allow her to live out her days at our farm. As I became aware of her lineage, I became intrigued with the idea of raising a foal from her. Last year, she was booked to So Surreal. She was bred to him through two heat cycles and failed to catch. I decided to revert back to plan one.

“As time went on and Velocity Lady continued to race well, I decided to give her one more shot, this time to Velocity Lady’s sire Bettors Delight. There were several issues to go through

to get there though. The first was money. How was I going to pay the high stud fee that Bettors Delight commanded? A close cousin of mine, Lydia Ann Miller, had recently passed and bequeathed me an inheritance. If I decided to go ahead with the mating that would be used to pay the stud fee. I reached out to Blue Chip Farms – the stallion manager of Bettors Delight – to attempt to get a booking. That was granted and plans were made to ship her to Blue Chip to be inseminated. She is now safely in foal and will soon be back domiciled with us. She is due to foal on Feb. 24, 2024.”

You have seven head in training today. How do they stack up?

“We have four at Vernon Downs which isn’t too far from us. We have two with Rob and Patti Harmon including a 2-year-old International Moni colt that we bought at Harrisburg last year.

The preliminary reports on him are quite promising. We also have one racing in Minnesota. In a relatively short period of time, we have managed to cover a decent geographical swath: New York, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Massachusetts, Ohio and Minnesota with Ontario to look forward to.

“We rarely leave the farm mostly because of the responsibilities of horse ownership require that we be around. I follow harness racing, specifically our horses, avidly. I watch The Meadowlands, Pocono, Chester, the New York tracks, Iowa racetracks and Running Aces regularly. Of course, I follow Velocity Lady’s races without fail. I enjoy cooking and love exploring different food venues. Caring for the horses, which I regard as a true labor of love, following just about every facet of harness racing and cooking make for a pretty full life.”

Have you had any people who you regard as your teachers?

“Actually, you are one of them. I read your columns and posts on Facebook without fail. Rarely does a day go by when I don’t pick up something of value. Another that I follow is Bob Marks as well as Clay Horner and Rick Armstrong. I miss Ronnie Gurfein. Also, such people as Charlie Longo, the extended Roland family from Iowa, Rob and Patti Harmon and Sarah and Joe Osmeloski, New York trainers that are neighbors of mine.”

If all goes as planned, you will be getting a new arrival next year. What are your plans as of now?

“If she carries safely, she will be shipped to Cornell approximately a month before her due date where she would foal. I’m hoping for a filly, but I will be more than happy to get whatever comes, so long as it is healthy. Lady Mattgalane has carried her age well. Although she is 19, if you were told that she is only five you would have no problem accepting that.

“I’m hoping for a filly for two main reasons. The first is that I hope to continue the line. The second is that based on my experience with Cantore, I have my doubts about my ability to raise an entire stud colt. Cantore got quite rambunctious at a relatively young age necessitating that he be promptly gelded. I see very little, if any advantage to raising a Bettors Delight gelding. Regardless of whether it’s a colt or filly it won’t be destined for any ownership other than my own. I hope to raise it myself and even perhaps to begin its ground training before sending it for race training. But that is a long way in the future.”

Ashley MacDonald – Third generation PEI horsetwoman

Ashley MacDonald is one of the lucky ones that call Prince Edward Island (PEI) home.

If you're involved in harness racing, perhaps you've never had the opportunity to race at a track on PEI, but there are many famous horsepeople and horses that have called the island home. In fact, statistics show that Canada is home to a variety of approximately 500,000 horses.

Several renowned PEI-born horsemen are Joe O'Brien, Jim McDonald, Wally Hennessey and the MacDonald brothers: Anthony, James and Mark, all who came from PEI: also known as "The Kentucky of Canada."

PEI has two live horse racing venues racing under the Red Shores banner: Charlottetown Driving Park and Summerside.

The roots of harness racing run deep on Prince Edward Island and are an integral part of its heritage. It has been this way for a long time, for it is reported that PEI hosted match racing as far back as the 1800's.

Organized harness racing made its first appearance in the year 1850 in Charlottetown when ice races were conducted on a one-mile circuit on the Charlottetown harbor.

The prestigious Gold Cup and Saucer Races became the premier racing event in the Atlantic Provinces, running the first race on Aug. 19, 1960. This successful beginning would be the start of many great things offered to harness racing fans.

Ashley was born into the game as both of her parents were "obsessed" with the sport and formed a stable together.

"My grandmother was also a pioneer for women in horse racing, as she was an owner, trainer, driver and farrier," Ashley said. "She is definitely where I get my confidence.

"My stable consists of two horses. The first is my homebred: a 3-year-old pacing colt named Sir Vaylance by He's Watching out of Colonisee Obligee by Art Colony. As a 2-year-old he trained down great to 2:18 but was so big that I made the decision to quit with him to let him finish growing.

"When I brought him back in, I took him to PEI and he's now been in 2:26 and looks good. I also have another homebred: a 2-year-old trotting colt named Worklikeacharm, by El Platinum out of Charming Oaks by Kadabra. He is staked to Delaware, which has a late stake program. My plan for him is to have a couple starts over Charlottetown Driving Park or Summerside and if he's solid I'll take him across the border and see how it goes."

This is Ashley's first year on PEI since 2008.

"I am stabled at the O'Leary Fairgrounds, which is conveniently 15 minutes from the home farm," she said. "If my horse, Sir Vaylance, shows talent I'll take him back to Ontario and if my father needs me to take some 2- or 3-year-olds across the border for stakes, I'll be spending a big part of the summer in Jersey or Pennsylvania."

Ashley's father, Ronald MacDonald, is originally from Charlottetown, PEI and her sister, Vanessa, attended the University of Prince Edward Island there. Her brother, Brett, tries to go to Old Home Week every year.

Last year, Ashley was a Gold Cup and Saucer Ambassador, representing No Plan Intended, who finished second. Her brother, Brett, drove the third place horse, Rhodena Road.

Her family is closely connected to Dusty Lane Farms in Cornwall, PEI which is owned by the Gass family.

"As a teenager I paddocked horses for my cousin, John MacDonald and looked after his horses," Ashley said. "Firethorn and One False Move both came up in 2011 for the Gold Cup and Saucer trials. Firethorn finished second in the finals."

When Ashley wasn't paddocking, she attended a lot of horse shows throughout Ontario and Quebec, which led her to work for a show jumper, Liubov Kochetova (RUS).

"While at The Toronto Film School, I would sneak away to travel from Long Beach to Vegas to Kentucky to Washington and other places to obtain points for the Olympic qualifiers in 2016," Ashley said. "After school I went to work at Determination Stable and went across the border working as Luc Blais' second trainer in New Jersey in 2019 where we won the Hambletonian with Forbidden Trade."

"I travelled with Emoticon Hanover and Dream Together, for the Miss Versatility series. Both mares made the final on Little Brown Jug Day in Delaware, OH. [Emoticon finished second and Dream finished fourth]."

After parting ways with Determination, Ashley became friends with Mark Etsell while stabled together.

"I had two stalls on the end of trainer Mark Etsell's barn," Ashley said. "Mark is a phenomenal trainer who puts a lot of slow miles in his horses, but they are ready when they need to be. My favorite driver is Bob McClure who is also great with horses for he has a lot of patience and he is one of my best friends. Together we have been part of two super teams: Determination, and then being teamsters at Etsell's."

"Having only two horses enabled me to go a lot of training sets with Mark. We shipped to Mohawk for qualifiers and I paddocked Adare Castle during her 2-year-old stake season, as well as others like Sea Can."

Ashley's boyfriend, Jansen Sweet, is a paramedic with Island EMS and a horseman who operates a small racing stable. He has several broodmares that are family co-owned that he keeps at his farm, Timberlea Standardbreds.

Ashley is now working with Jason and they are both over the hill in love with their new Roll With Joe—String Bikini colt.

"Jansen and his owners bought String Bikini in November and we shipped her to PEI from New York," Ashley said. "I was there for the birth of the foal. I really enjoyed the experience once the colt was dried and standing and I knew he was alright. My father's mare, Charming Oaks, is the dam to my 2-year-old colt. Last year she had a big Holiday Road filly and is now in foal to PEI stallion, EL Rocket."

"My 2023 goal is to have fun bringing along the young horses and managing the broodmares and yearlings with Jansen. We are hoping to expand the property and build another barn."

My plan is to keep one or two of the yearlings and possibly buy a yearling out of my grandmother's trotting stud in Indiana, Uno Jantara. I love breaking yearlings and watching them grow into racehorses. I'd like to expand my knowledge into what goes on at the yearling sales at Harrisburg and Kentucky and perhaps start making yearling videos, combining what I learned at the Toronto Film industry with my love for horses."

Records tumble in Paul Revere at Plainridge Park

The \$100,000 Paul Revere Pace for 3-year-olds in 2023 was held at Plainridge Park on Thursday afternoon (May 4) and featured a select group of speedy side-wheelers that went to post in two \$50,000 divisions and broke both the stakes and track records.

The first division was won by **Thunder Hunter Joe** (Huntsville—Thunder Angel) who followed fast early fractions to capture a career best win.

Peppermint Man (Mitch Cushing) played hard ball with Metal Man (Greg Merton), parking him to the quarter in :25.3 before he was able to clear and cross over. Metal Man then set up shop on the top and continued the torrid pace with a :54 half. As they rolled by that station, Ben Solo (Dexter Dunn) pulled first-over and Thunder Hunter Joe (Tyler Buter) followed loosely in the outer flow.

Ben Solo cleared at the five-eighths while Thunder Hunter Joe continued to grind in the breeze. Positions remained unchanged around the last turn and Ben Solo took a gapped advantage into the stretch. Buter started to get after Thunder Hunter Joe to make up the difference and the gelding responded enthusiastically. Thunder Hunter Joe paced hard in the lane and got the jump at the light, winning by three-quarters of a length in 1:51.

The time was a new lifetime mark for the winner and also established a new stakes record.

It was the second straight win in only two 2023 starts for Thunder Hunter Joe (\$6.00) who is owned by Devita Racing Stable, David Hamm, Glenn Phillips and Christopher Giaccio. Nicholas Devita trains the winner who was bred by Heather Zitone.

The second division went to **Caviart Scotland** (American Ideal—Darlin's Delight) who led at every station to claim his first lifetime win and set some records of his own.

Driver Josert Fonseca pushed Caviart Scotland off the gate and to the lead, seating Sheer Terror (Bret Beckwith) and Goldin Greatness (Dexter Dunn) in the process. Everyone paced in place through a :26.4 quarter and :54.2 half before Dunn tipped

Goldin Greatness off the pylons nearing the five-eighths. Goldin Greatness then advanced quickly on the outside and drew alongside Caviart Scotland in the final bend.

Halfway through the turn, Fonseca popped the plugs on his charge and Caviart Scotland responded and shifted gears. At the seven-eighths pole, Caviart Scotland started to pull away from Goldin Greatness and with no other challenge imminent, Caviart Scotland headed for home under a line drive and cruised to a 2-¼ length victory in 1:50.3.

The winning time was a new lifetime mark for Caviart Scotland, reset the stakes record from the first leg and also smashed the track record for 3-year-old pacing colts at Plainridge Park.

Caviart Scotland (\$15.80) is owned by Caviart Farms and trained by Nancy Takter. White Birch Farms bred the winner.

The old stakes record for the Paul Revere Pace was 1:52.1 set by Groovy Man in 2022 at Plainridge Park and the track record of 1:51.1 for 3-year-old pacing colts was co-held by Shoobee's Place (2010) and Sports Obsession (2020).

Live racing resumes at Plainridge Park on Monday (May 8) at 4 p.m.

Hot Mess Express wins at Big M

Hot Mess Express got into the win column for the first time in five seasonal starts Friday night (May 5) at The Meadowlands in a mid-level conditioned pace for mares and her driver is hopeful the lifetime earner of over \$850,000 can get back to being the kind of horse she was earlier in her career.

"I think [she'll be able to go with the good horses in her division]," Scott Zeron said. "Half-mile tracks aren't her specialty. She's getting her confidence back."

Hot Mess Express, who is owned by former NBA standout Sam Bowie, started the year with three unspectacular outings in the Blue Chip Matchmaker series at Yonkers, but rebounded with a good third-place finish at The Big M on April 29 before taking her first winner's circle photo of the year Friday night.

The 5-year-old daughter of Panther Hanover—My Heart Was True had a stellar 3-year-old season during 2021 when she banked over \$630,000, which included a win in the Mistletoe Shalee at The Meadowlands in a lifetime-best 1:48.3.

On Friday, she had to overcome post 10, but proved up to the challenge.

"She was great tonight," Zeron said. "My plan was just to leave and reassess in the first turn. I decided to take a little relief [by sitting a four-hole trip]."

Hot Mess Express went after leader Huntress down the backside, was within 1½ lengths of that foe at the top of the stretch before wearing her down nearing the wire to record a safe three-quarter-length score in 1:51.2. Huntress held second with Miss Chantilly N third.

"She's a good grinder," Zeron said. "And I thought she was the class of the field."

A Tony Alagna trainee, Hot Mess Express has now won precisely one-half of her 46 lifetime starts. As the 6-5 favorite, she returned \$4.40 to her backers.

THE STREAK LIVES: Despite a slow start that saw two of first three races see wagering fail to exceed \$143,000 and four fields that had seven starters or less, The Meadowlands' streak of \$3-million handles endured.

There have been 33 Friday and Saturday night programs contested at the mile oval during 2023 (not counting one that was canceled after seven races due to bad weather) and each one has seen betting bust the \$3-million barrier.

All-source wagering on Friday's 14-race card was \$3,051,780.

During 2022, there were a total of 85 race cards contested at The Big M, with 23 exceeding the \$3-million mark.

A LITTLE MORE: The 20-cent Survivor remains one of the better bets at The Big M, as those with winning tickets cashed in for \$7,339.30 despite only needing six winning selections. Winner's odds during the sequence were 6-5, 9-2, 8-5, 8-1, 6-5, 5-2 and 3-1, as five were sent to the gate as the favorite. The Brett Pelling-trained 3-year-old gelding **Command** (Captaintreacherous—Fable) used a pocket trip to gun down the previously unbeaten Ants Marching in a sparkling 1:50 as the 6-5 public choice.
