Trainer Todd Luther has a healthy perspective on being charged with making his brother Greg's "million-dollar experiment" a success.

"It's either going to go really well or... I joke with people all the time and say, 'I've got my Walmart application filled out if this don't pan out," Todd said last week as horses such as Water Sports Teen, A Fancy Face and Captains Place all picked up checks in stakes races in Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

Greg is a successful real estate coach based in Ohio who decided in 2020 to spend at least \$1 million to stock Todd's stable with potential stars.

Through four months, Todd's stable has already earned over \$300,000 in fewer than half the starts he had in all of 2020 when his outfit earned a record \$483,013.

Todd said he's thrilled to be given the opportunity of a lifetime, but admits it has brought some added pressure to

"It's tough, you know, because I want to do my best. My biggest fear is failing, and I do not want to fail. I don't want to be the laughingstock, for the money that he's spent, but every day, everybody in the barn comes to work hard. The pressure, I think, will mount up later in the year once they all get racing, but so far so good, I think," Todd said.

"We've come a long way from the claimers. It's a totally new ball game. From prepping horses other than claimers that you race every week, to now prepping horses for the races we want to be in, I've been very fortunate this year... that Greg said, 'We're going to be put on the map."

Todd, whose main stable is based at Virgil Morgan's Winner Circle Training Center near Columbus, OH, said he's training 48 horses for Greg, who goes by the stable name Black Magic Racing LLC.

Sure, there's some jealousy in the industry that he's suddenly been gifted a stable full of talented horses, but most people are happy to see Todd Luther get his shot at training great horses and attempting to win classics such as the Little Brown Jug and Meadowlands Pace.

In a game needing new faces and new investors, it's an early favorite for feel-good story of the year.

"There's as many haters as there are people rooting me on, but here at Virgil's back home, on race days, my phone is blowing up all the time with people just saying good luck and 'We hope that you make it.' So, we're going to give it 100 per cent," Todd said.

Saturday (May 15), Todd will start Chief Mate in the second of two \$50,000 Graduate divisions at The Meadowlands in the second leg of the series.

Two weeks ago, Todd made his first start at The Big M in more than five years when Chief Mate, a horse that topped this year's January Tattersalls Winter Mixed Sale with a bid of \$220,000 (U.S.), finished third in his first leg Graduate test.

"I was very excited to be on the big stage and nervous at the same time," Todd said, adding he's only raced one other horse at the Meadowlands.

"I had a horse that was out east a long time ago, I think five or six years, and we needed a start and just raced him there and he was just in a non-winners of one, but this is the first time on the big stage like that and it was very exciting."

On Sunday (May 16), Luther will race sophomore pacing colts Water Sports Teen and Captains Place at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono in divisions of the Pennsylvania Sires Stakes (PASS) and Pennsylvania Stallion Series, respectively.

Todd said his brother has long talked about buying a bunch of talented horses, but something different came over Greg during last fall's yearling sales.

"Any one that we had picked out, he bought. Then, when the Meadowlands sale came out, he said, 'Let's just keep going. Let's get us some Grand Circuit horses," Todd said.

Greg then bought a few horses — including Water Sports Teen — from the estate of noted breeder and owner Bob Key. Greg then took his horse acquisition hobby online.

"He has a website, www.sellmyhorsenow.com and we bought a few off of that. I have a bunch of blank checks, so if we see something we like, it's free will, pretty much, to buy. We don't want to overpay, but he wants the top-calibre horses," Todd said, adding he would love to win the Meadowlands Pace one day and his brother's biggest dream is to win the Jug.

"I used to train at Delaware," Todd said.

As for whether he owes Greg a big Christmas present this year, Todd said he's already working on it.

"I'm hoping that my big Christmas gift is for these horses to perform like I think they will for him," Todd said. "I think it would be kind of cool to start from the claimers and get to where we are now and I think we have the horses in the barn that can compete on a very high level."

# Rhyme and reason for Big M success for partnership of Brennan and Drennan

What sound do you hear when George Brennan drives for Nik Drennan? Cha-ching!

The combo of Brennan and trainer Drennan has been highly successful at The Meadowlands in 2021, due in part due to Yonkers Raceway being closed on Saturdays.

"[Drennan] had Environs Hanover and he was in on Saturday [Feb. 20] in his first race [of the season] and he said, 'Do you want to come over?'" said Brennan. "And we won that first start."

Brennan told HRU in December 2020 that there was a short list of trainers he'd motor up the New Jersey Turnpike for on a Saturday night and Drennan was definitely one of them.

That decision has certainly paid off for the fans since the pair continued to win and amassed a total of five victories from only six starts over the next month.

One of those wins was with Sundown Kid, who had previously been driven by Mark MacDonald.

"The first start we raced [Sundown Kid], Mark MacDonald drove him and me and George were standing there watching the race, and he said, 'That horse should have a gaiting pole on the inside,'" said Drennan. "The next start we put it on and we also added Lasix and tinkered with some equipment and he did win and paid [almost] \$50 with George driving. If he suggests the horse needs a snakecord on or a bigger headpole, absolutely [I'm listening]."

It's important to note that Drennan did not just give the drive on Sundown Kid to Brennan, it was MacDonald who chose to give it up.

"Mark booked off him and that's why George was driving him," said Drennan. "So, it wasn't like I took Mark off. Mark

took another horse and George ended up on him and we kept tinkering and it worked out."

Part of what makes Brennan, 54, and Drennan, 38, click on the track, is their long friendship.

"It goes way back to when he was a kid working for Tony Montini and I was driving for him then and then he went on his own and I continued driving for him and did well," said Brennan.

In 2007, Drennan moved to the States from Canada to work for Montini and run his New Jersey operation. A few years later, when Drennan went on his own, Brennan was one of the many drivers he used at The Big M.

Brennan made his Meadowlands debut on the day after Christmas in 1994, and by 1997, he was already a top-five driver at the track and had great success there over the years, including a driving title in 2010 and winning the Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks on the same day in 2011.

"[Alexie Mattosie] won the [2011] William Haughton Memorial for me 10 years ago, and [Brennan] drove him for me," said Drennan. "We weren't really close friends back then, but over the years, we've become pretty good friends.

"It's just kind of worked out [this year] that he was available and I had a bunch of horses to race. And he's just as good as he's ever been, in my opinion, so why not?"

Brennan has nothing but good things to say about Drennan and how he operates his stable.

"He reminds me of Nifty Norman on a much smaller scale," said Brennan. "He works just like Nifty does. Same work ethic. He's at the barn at 4:30 in the morning. He's feeding, he's turning horses out. He's hands on and that's how Nifty is, who I have the utmost respect for.

"[Drennan's] my friend and I want to do good for my friend and I like seeing my friend do well. And I can give him input from week to week also. With me driving them every week, I can give him the input of how the horse performed from one week to another week."

Drennan and Brennan agree that being like-minded and candid contributes to their success.

"He's honest after the race," said Drennan. "He doesn't try to sugarcoat anything. I'm the same way. If a horse is no good, just tell me he's no good. If he's no good, he's no good, and we've got to work on something. That's why me and him get along so well. We're on the same page and I don't have to tell him anything, anytime about how to drive a horse. Maybe the first time he drives one I tell him a little bit about the horse, but that's it. And he's good with a hot horse and he's good with a lazy horse."

In 32 Big M starts in 2021, Brennan and Drennan have earned a check 69 per cent of the time. They are hitting the board at a 47 per cent clip with 25 per cent of those being wins.



"It's always great to win at The Meadowlands, regardless of whether it's for Nik or somebody else I'm driving for. But winning for Nik makes it extra special because we're such close friends," said Brennan. "The Meadowlands is just in a league of its own. It's just a great place."

In December of 2020, Brennan joked with HRU about the thought of driving regularly at The Meadowlands again.

"It'll be like, 'Oh wow, George Brennan still is alive?", he said.

If the stats are any indication, Brennan's always alive at The Meadowlands.

# Forty years on, Cheryl O'Mara's first trip to the track still deeply memorable

Cheryl O'Mara's first visit to the racetrack turned out to be a life-altering experience.

She was just 16 when she decided to tag along for a trip to the local harness oval in Michigan, an opportunity, at the very least, to see standardbreds up-close and in-person.

A fan of all things horses, O'Mara, at the time, had never give a second's thought of what it would be like to carve out a long-term, prosperous career in the horse racing industry.

But after standing by the rail for a few hours and watching intently as the horses flew by, she started to think about what a life in racing might be like.

"I was born in raised in Jackson, Michigan, and there was a racetrack, Jackson Raceway. My uncle, my dad's brother, came over to the house and then we all went to the racetrack. I've always loved horses since I was a little girl and I used to barrel race and go to horse shows, so I knew I would like going to see the horses at the racetrack."

So much so, in fact, that O'Mara didn't want to leave – both that night and long after.

The sights and sounds, the energy of watching races under the lights, all of it captivated the then-teenager and high school student.

"When we went to the racetrack that night, I just loved the atmosphere, and seeing how these wonderful animals perform. I can still remember that night. Everything seemed so perfect. As for the horses, they're amazing. I just fell in love with it all right there and then."

Over 40 years later, her devotion to racing and racehorses is as strong as it's ever been.

Working as a caretaker in the barn of trainer Joe Putnam, O'Mara has had the opportunity to work closely with several

accomplished pacers and trotters, including Rockin Nola.

Campaigned by Putnam and his son Joey, Rockin Nola won the most races at Harrah's Hoosier Park in 2020. The daughter of Rockin Image made nine trips to the winner's circle over the 111-night racing campaign.

The mare, now 5, tied her career best mark of 1:49.4 in July and overall took 10 of 17 starts for JP Racing and Suttons Bay Racing, who purchased her for \$15,000 at the Hoosier Classic Yearling Sale.

"She's an interesting horse. She can be handful, but I let her get away with a lot of things. When you go to get her ready, she likes to kick and bite. She is very strong willed. But I love her. Joe would tell you that I have her too spoiled, but all good mares get away with a lot."

Picking a favorite horse is a near-impossible task for O'Mara, who also worked in Canada for Hall of Fame trainer Bob McIntosh.

There are more than a few, however, that quickly come to mind, including Sum It Up, a two-time fair circuit champion.

"My dad bought his racehorse – the first one he ever owned – Sugar Puff, and that was the first horse I took care of. She definitely stands out for me. He bought me another one, Lobe Lad, whose nickname on the track was "Dirty Harry," because no one liked driving him. Sum It Up, owned by Joe Putnam and myself, gave us a lot of thrills. He always raced his heart out. I started working for Dan and Mary-Lou O'Hara, who taught me everything. I started out cleaning stalls and then gradually became a caretaker. That was my biggest stable... they had 15 horses. I remember one they had, Soul Michelle. She was a little, short thing, but she had the biggest heart.

"I then went on to work for Gord Norris. I was friends with his daughter. Gord had one particular horse – he claimed it at Hazel Park for \$8,000 – named Shadow Fly Fly. That horse went from an \$8,000 claimer to an invitational pacer. I really loved that one, too. Another one was Golden Raintree. He was a handful, but I loved him, too. When I worked in Canada, there was a horse named Delinquent Account [a millionaire daughter of On The Road Again, trained by McIntosh]. She won me my first Breeders Crown and that was a wonderful memory."

Upper-tier performers or lower-level claimers, O'Mara's measure of affection for the horses she takes care of isn't based on wins or speed badges.

They are all equal in her eyes.

"I see them as my children. Every horse has a unique personality, a different way of doing things. I just always want to make sure that I give them my all of my attention and my best care. You know them inside and inside out. You get to know their routines and you can tell when they are doing well or they aren't. You learn about them every day and that creates a bond."

O'Mara, whose three sons, Chad, Jeremy, and Justin Morrison, all work in standardbred racing, believes horses know when they've won, even if they happen to be a little camera-shy.


"They do. They definitely do. When Rockin Nola wins, she doesn't like standing in the winner's circle. She hears the camera and once it's done clicking, she wants out of there. She'll rear up and leap forward. You only have a few seconds to get a picture of her. She has a tough attitude, but all the goods one need it, and I think it helps them when they're on the racetrack."

Forty-plus years after that visit to Jackson Raceway, O'Mara, now 57, doesn't have plans to call it a career any time soon.

Not when she can be around the horses.

"I still love it. I don't think I'll ever change my life. I love the harness horses. There is just something about them that makes you want to be around them every day. I feel very lucky to be able to do that. Every time I see my horses, it puts a smile on my face. You could be having a really bad day, but the horses always make you feel great."







# Hickothepooh upsets in Finland, earns spot in Elitloppet

The \$133,000 Finlandia-ajo mile race was held at Vermo racetrack in Helsinki, Finland on Sunday (May 9) afternoon and a serious upset winner secured a spot in this year's Elitloppet.

Trond Andersen trained Hickothepooh (Triton Sund), driven by Vidar Hop, was the unlikely winner with a quarter remaining of the prestigious race when he was fourth over, but when leader Milliondollarrhyme, who passed the half mile in :54.4, ran completely out of power at mid-stretch, Hickothepooh's finish was enough to sprint to a safe win in 1:52.2.

Nine-year-old Hickothepooh was probably not one of the first horses that was mentioned as an Elitloppet contender this year, but the victory in Finland means that Norway will have at least one horse to root for at Solvalla on May 30.

Next Direction finished well as the runner up ahead of Vernissage Grif.

# Big question mark for Dorgos de Guez

Jean-Michel Bazire's Dorgos de Guez, who is invited to Elitloppet, was big favorite in the \$125,000 Prix Kerjacques at Vincennes on Sunday (May 9) afternoon. But Bazire's trotter left the arena with lots of question marks surrounding him after a weak effort on Vincennes' big track.

Instead, Bazire could rejoice since Davidson du Pont (Pacha du Pont) was back as a winner in France. Driven by Nicolas Bazire, the Prix d'Amérique runner up Davidson du Pont finished strongly and came home in a mile rate 1:55.4 over 1.6 miles.



Dorgos de Guez did not have his best day at the track and it seems very uncertain if Bazire will race his chestnut gelding at Solvalla in two weeks.

# **New names for Elitloppet**

Delia du Pommereux received a ticket for Elitloppet after her impressive win in Paralympiatravet last weekend, but since Eric Raffin was handed a whipping penalty by the judges at Åby racetrack, it seems likely the people behind Delia du Pommereux will decide to stay home.

Svante Båth's Very Kronos (Ready Cash) was runner up behind Delia du Pommereux and Båth received an invitation for Elitloppet earlier this week.

Milliondollarrhyme (Ready Cash), who got too fired up in the lead in Finlandia-ajo, got his ticket for Elitloppet on Wednesday afternoon and when \$24,000 The Onion's race was held at Solvalla on Wednesday (May 12) night, another ticket for Elitloppet was at stake. That ticket was claimed by Heavy Sound (Ken Warkentin), who lead all the way for driver Kenneth Haugstad.

# **Racing reflections with Scott Farber**

Breeder/owner Scott Farber of Runthetable Stables admires horses with a competitive spirit. It comes as no surprise given that Farber was a fierce competitor as a pitcher at William Paterson College, where he was an All-American and still owns the best career win percentage (.952, 20-1) and earned-run average (2.13) in school history.

Farber's top moment came in 1992 when he helped WPC to the NCAA Division III national championship. Farber tossed a six-hit complete game in a 3-1 victory over California-Lutheran, striking out the side in the bottom of the ninth inning to clinch the title.

"The only thing I really like to see from my horses is heart," Farber said. "I like to have horses in my stable that want to race, that want to compete, because that's what I was. I was a competitor. I like that quality in my horses."

Farber's introduction to racing came through his father, Sandy. Father and son would spend their weekends together going to the New York City-area tracks and his dad eventually got involved in harness racing as a horse owner when Farber was in his mid-teens.

"I loved it so much, being a part of it, that I asked to get a job on the backstretch at The Meadowlands," Farber said. "I got a job with (trainer) Alan Kirschenbaum and my interest in horses only got greater from there."

The first horse to impact Farber's life was a female pacer named Steady Margaret.

"I spent a lot of time in the stall with her, a lot of extra time, just loving on her and her loving on me," Farber said. "I had a real connection with that horse. I really enjoyed her. She was a lot of fun to be around. She hooked me immediately on horses.

"I rooted for her when she would race, but the connection we had one-on-one was more important to me than how she performed on the track."

If Steady Margaret ignited Farber's love for the sport and horses, pacer Run The Table cemented it. Run The Table was

Sandy Farber's best horse, winning 14 of 24 races and \$904,022 as a 3-year-old in 1987. He was the first horse to defeat future Hall of Famer Jate Lobell, snapping the colt's win streak at 18, in a race at The Meadowlands.

"Seeing my father's success with Run The Table only made me want to do more," Farber said. "I was only 17 years old when that was going on. Just to be a part of that, 50 people in the winner's circle and the excitement before the horse races, the adrenaline rush, I fell in love with it.

"Jate Lobell was an outstanding horse. For us to knock him off for the first time, it's a feeling I'll never forget. But Run The Table gave us a lot of those type feelings. He was a tough one. He was in with a tough group of horses, but every week he came to play. Run The Table certainly was a competitor."

Sandy Farber died in 2004, but Scott continued in the sport. He got his first taste of his own Grand Circuit success as an owner with the trotter Opening Night, who was third in the 2011 Hambletonian Stakes and a Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion.

In the mid-2010s, Farber started a small breeding operation. It pushed his stable to new heights last year when homebreds Next Level Stuff won the Breeders Crown for 3-year-old female trotters, Hobbs captured the New York Sire Stakes championship for 3-year-old male trotters, and Take All Comers won on the Grand Circuit for 2-year-old male trotters.

Farber's Runthetable Stables, which topped \$1 million in earnings for the first time in 2020, was nominated for Breeder of the Year by the U.S. Harness Writers Association. Brittany Farms captured the award.

"It was an unbelievable experience," Farber said of the nomination. "But I don't do this alone. I've had a lot of help. I work with Joell Arnold from Turbot Acres in Pennsylvania. She handles all my broodmares and does a fantastic job. She's a big part in the breeding success that my stable has been fortunate enough to have.

"There are two other people that I really lean on, and whose opinions I really respect, and that's Steve Stewart and

Dr. J (Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky). They have been extremely receptive to my questions, phone calls, emails, my smoke signals, you name it. They've really been great. I would not have had the success I've had without a lot of luck and without their input."

Farber also has a longstanding relationship with trainer Jim Campbell, who began training horses for his father with Run The Table in 1987.

"I feel that when you work with the best people, you're going to get results," Farber said.

When Farber won the national championship at William Paterson, after the game he jumped into the stands and gave his father the game ball.

"That was the most satisfying feeling that I got out of it," Farber said. "I wasn't the greatest kid growing up. I wasn't in any major trouble, but I was a little difficult to deal with. I kind of feel like that wiped the slate clean between us for all I put him through."

After Farber watched Next Level Stuff win her Breeders Crown last October, his father again was foremost on his mind.

"My father was my idol, I think I made that pretty clear," Farber said referring to his comments in the winner's circle following the filly's victory, when he stated: "My stable is named after my father, who I loved with all my heart. He was my best friend in the entire world. I just miss him so much and I hope that I made him proud."

Next Level Stuff is back racing at age 4 and Farber knows it can be a difficult transition for horses when they have to race against older foes. Farber has no expectations, but also knows his mare possesses his favorite quality.

"She is a real competitor," Farber said. "She wants to race. She wants to go a hundred miles an hour at all times and I admire that. She gave me a thrill of my lifetime and nobody can take that Breeders Crown away from her. I've watched the video of that race hundreds of times. If it shows a thousand views, 976 of them are mine. It was a wonderful feeling.

"To me, everything now with her is icing on the cake."

# Concentration is key for Wellwood pupil Muscle Dynasty

When it comes to physical talent, Muscle Dynasty checks all the boxes for trainer Paula Wellwood. When it comes to focusing on his work, though, the 3-year-old trotter leaves Wellwood scratching her head.

Muscle Dynasty is one of 20 Hambletonian-eligible horses entered in tonight's (May 14) opening round of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for 3-year-old male trotters at The Meadowlands. The colt, who won last year's New Jersey Futurity, competes in the third of three \$25,000 NJSS divisions.

For his career, Muscle Dynasty has won three of 15 races and hit the board a total of seven times. He has gone off



stride in seven starts, including his most recent on May 7 at The Meadowlands against a field of mostly older rivals in a conditioned event.

"He has all the tools, but he doesn't have a brain to go with them," Wellwood said. "It's concentration, that's all it is. He's got all the attributes. He doesn't do anything wrong, he's a lovely horse, but his concentration will lapse. It's aggravating because he's such a pleasure.

"Talent-wise, it's there. Whether we can get the brain to match, I don't know."

Hambletonian hopeful Muscle Dynasty will start in the New Jersey Sires Stakes tonight (May 14) at The Meadowlands.

Muscle Dynasty, named Storm The Hill originally, is by Muscle Hill out of Miss Liv. He was purchased for \$55,000 at the 2019 Lexington Selected Sale and is owned by Dreamville Stable, which is Wellwood, her husband and training partner Mike Keeling, son Devin Keeling, and mom Jean Wellwood. The family shared the experience of winning the 2016 Hambletonian, and subsequently the Trotting Triple Crown, with Marion Marauder.

Wellwood has tinkered with Muscle Dynasty's equipment in the hopes of improving the colt's focus, but nothing has clicked.

"He was like this last year," Wellwood said. "We gave him the benefit of the doubt and thought he would grow up, but he hasn't. Every day is a new day in his world. What happened yesterday is gone.

"He takes nothing seriously. He's just like a big kid and he doesn't want to mature. It's not there yet anyway. He trains good, he's a sound horse, he's a big, strong horse. If the switch gets flipped, he's going to be a very, very nice horse."

Muscle Dynasty faces seven rivals Friday, with six eligible to August's \$1 million Hambletonian, including 2-1 morning-line favorite Take This Society from the stable of trainer Nancy Takter.

In the first division, Cuatro De Julio is the 9-5 favorite for trainer Marie Ortolan Bar. Ake Svanstedt's Lindysmusclemania is the 5-2 favorite in the second division. That field also includes Valley Victory winner Bee Forever and Peter Haughton Memorial champ Zenith Stride.

The Meadowlands tonight will also play host to two 11-horse divisions of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for 3-year-old female trotters. Seventeen of the fillies are eligible to August's Hambletonian Oaks, including

Wellwood-trained Limoges.

Limoges, who is in the second NJSS division, made her career debut on May 3 at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono. She was three-wide around the final turn and last at the top of the stretch but closed strongly to finish fourth, beaten by only one length.

She missed last season because of an injury.

"We were just ready to qualify her when she had a crack in a knee and we had to quit," Wellwood said. "But she always showed ability. She was very good gaited, wanted to do her work, and had some speed. She had all the attributes needed. We gave her a lot of time and, knock on wood, we have no issues right now."

Limoges is by Trixton out of Spice Queen. She was purchased for \$40,000 at the 2019 Standardbred Horse Sale and is owned by Dreamville Stable. She is a half-sister to Grand Circuit winner Dancing For Money, who is the dam of O'Brien Award winner Dip Me Hanover. Wellwood shared a connection with both those horses, either as trainer or owner.

"We're very happy with her," Wellwood said about Limoges. "She's grown up and gotten stronger, she just doesn't know anything. She's so very green. But she is getting it. I think when she figures it out, she's going to be OK."

Imhatra AM S, trained by Marcus Melander, is the 5-2 morning-line favorite in the second NJSS division. Eazy Pass, from the stable of Nifty Norman, is the 9-5 favorite in the first.

Racing begins at 6:20 p.m. (EDT) tonight at The Meadowlands. The Big M and TrackMaster have teamed to regularly provide free past performances for each race card. Past performances can be found **here** on The Meadowlands' website.

# Yonkers Trot, Messenger get purse increases to \$500,000

Yonkers Raceway is pleased to announce that the four major Grand Circuit stakes scheduled for Friday, July 2 will all see substantial purse increases over the originally advertised amounts.

The MGM Yonkers Trot and MGM Grand Messenger Pace will see a purse boost from \$300,000 to \$500,000. The marquee races are scheduled as the first legs of the Triple Crown for 3-year-old trotters and pacers, respectively. The Pacing Triple Crown also includes the Cane Pace (Meadowlands) and Little Brown Jug (Delaware County Fair). After the Yonkers Trot, the Trotting Triple Crown continues with the Hambletonian (Meadowlands) and Kentucky Futurity (Red Mile).

The filly companion races will also get a nice purse boost. The Park MGM Pace and New York-New York Mile Trot will both bump up to \$150,000 from \$125,000.

"When we put the stakes schedule together back in November there was a great deal of uncertainty about 2021, so we took a very conservative approach to purse levels," said Yonkers director of racing Alex Dadoyan. "Now that we have seen significant reopening steps in New York, we were able to make these increases."

Elimination races for all four finals are scheduled for Friday, June 25.

Currently 44 trotting colts are eligible for the Yonkers Trot and 38 pacing colts have paid into the Messenger. For horses that haven't previously nominated, supplemental entries are accepted for both Triple Crown races at a cost of \$30,000. The filly events offer a \$15,000 late-entrance option.

Yonkers Raceway continues its Monday to Friday live racing schedule (post time 7:15 PM) through May 27. The track will then take a 10-day break and return to the normal five weeknights of racing on Monday, June 7.

# Bruce Ranger wins six at Plainridge Park

Bruce Ranger continued his torrid driving pace after scoring six more wins on the 11-race card at Plainridge Park on Thursday afternoon (May 13). Ranger, who has been in a nip-and-tuck battle with Shawn Gray since the beginning of the meet, extended his lead to seven wins today with Gray currently sidelined after an accident at Saratoga Raceway.

Among his six pack of races won, Ranger captured both \$15,000 conditioned events for 6-year-old and younger male pacers.

In the first division, Ranger put General Ward on the point at the quarter in :26.2 and then led every step of the way from there. After slowing the half to :55.4, General Ward hit the gas and sped home in back-to-back :27.3 panels to win going away by 2-3/4 lengths over Whata Foolbelieves (Matty Athearn) in 1:51.It was the first win in 11 starts this year and a new lifetime mark for General Ward (\$8.60) who had been racing regularly at Harrah's Philadelphia until he was privately purchased on May 1 by his current owner/trainer, Melissa Beckwith.

In the second division, Ranger came from off the pace fifth at the half with Force N Fury and swung three deep around fading cover at the five-eighths. Then he caught up with the leading Put It Right (Kevin Switzer Jr.) coming out of the last turn and paced by him at the line where he won by 3/4's of a length in 1:51.2.

It was the third win in the last four starts for Force N Fury (\$4.40) who has not been worse than second in five Plainridge starts. Force N Fury is owned by his trainer Mark Eaton along with Robert McHugh and Robert Griffin.

Ranger filled out his dance card with Frills N Lace (1:54.2, \$7.00), Cheyenne Toby (1:56, \$7.00), Captain Terror (1:54.2, \$4.80) and The Fun Marshall (1:53, \$2.60).

At the current Plainridge meet, Ranger has 34 wins in only 120 starts for a 28 per cent win percentage and a UDR of .311. Overall in 2020 he had driven 57 winners in 216 starts giving him a 26% win percentage and a UDR of .364.

Since 1979 Bruce Ranger had driven 9,422 winners and bankrolled \$38.9 million in purses.
