# Gural on why he's closing Vernon Downs and wants New Jersey to join HISA

The racetrack owner responds to criticism.

Jeff Gural, owner of The Meadowlands, Tioga Downs and Vernon Downs, was in the news on two major fronts this week. The Hall of Famer announced he has begun the process to close Vernon Downs by the end of the year. Gural also sent an email to the Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey (SBOANJ) detailing plans to lobby New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy to end horse racing's \$10 million annual subsidy in the state after one year unless the SBOANJ agrees to support a plan where New Jersey would opt into the thoroughbred-driven Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority.

Both instances are examples of Gural trying to use his political connections and influence to affect the changes he would like to see.

Naturally, both moves were heavily criticized on social media by Gural's nemesis Joe Faraldo, the president of the Standardbred Owners Association of New York (SOANY).



HRU was in the process of reaching out to Gural to ask about both matters when an email arrived from him explaining his motivation on both subjects.

On the possible closure of Vernon Downs — and it is still not a definite – Gural said he is simply trying to make the operation financially viable.

"The only reason I opened Vernon was because the horsemen begged me when it was closed and in bankruptcy," Gural wrote. "I knew, economically, it was a mistake because we were six miles from Turning Stone, the nicest casino in the state. On the other hand, as a horse owner and breeder Vernon has a great racing surface and since I breed trotters I thought it was vital to have at least one 7/8th mile oval in the state so I did a stupid thing and agreed to take it over.

"Having said that, once the five new casinos opened that surrounded Vernon in addition to Turning Stone it became impossible for us to compete and the state agreed to give us an additional 6.4 per cent vendor fee provided we maintain 90 per cent of the jobs that existed in 2016.

"Everything was fine until COVID-19 hit. Needless to say, we were not able to maintain the employment levels they required, so they revoked the 6.4 per cent vendor fee and, as expected, I lost \$2 million last year keeping it open.

"When I tried unsuccessfully to restore the 6.4 per cent so that I didn't lose another \$2 million they rejected that request and, as a result, I have no choice but to announce the closing.

"Hopefully, the union and the horsemen can make the argument that Vernon is important and convince the state to restore the 6.4% in which case Vernon will stay open. I am not aware of Faraldo writing any checks for \$2 million to help the horsemen survive in 2022, so it is no surprise that he is criticizing me for announcing the closure."

On HISA, Gural's May 4 email to the SBOANJ read:

"Based on the negative publicity coming out of Churchill Downs this week and the fact that the USTA (United States Trotting Association) is actively opposing the HISA legislation, I have decided to reach out to the Governor next week when I see him and tell him that I don't want the subsidy extended more than one year unless the SBOANJ agrees to support a plan whereby NJ would opt into HISA. I am optimistic we could get HISA to modify the regulations as they affect our industry as I already have a verbal commitment.

"[USTA president] Russell [Williams] and [USTA chair] Joe [Faraldo] could be leading us on a path of extinction once the public finds out how prevalent drugs have been in our industry. Keep in mind, 30 people were arrested and [are] in jail. Almost all of them were involved in the standardbred industry. On the other hand, the two thoroughbred trainers were the leading trainers at Monmouth, so that is a blackeye. I think it is critical that the Governor is in a position to defend the additional subsidy by tying it into the fact that the standardbred horsemen are prepared to lead the way and opt into HISA when the time comes. My guess is that will not be for at least another year or two as they will need to get the kinks out with the thoroughbreds.

"I have a good relationship with the Governor. I doubt if he is aware of what happened with all the arrests, but he will be after

I discuss it with him in the next few days. We are playing with fire here and the public is really going to be pissed when they find out how prevalent drugs are and the subsidy our industry receives in other states. Hopefully you and your members will agree. The USTA has put us in a terrible position and we have an opportunity to make the Governor look good here. We will also need his help if we want to get a casino eventually as well."

In his email to HRU, Gural further said:

"As far as HISA is concerned, the industry has a choice: they can either side with Jeff Gural or Joe Faraldo. I am committed to getting rid of the drugs in the sport. I have accomplished a great deal, but there is more to do and I am not satisfied that the current arrangement where the state is responsible to regulate the sport is the way to go.

"While hopefully The Meadowlands has eliminated most of the drugs I have been told by others that drugs are rampant in other jurisdictions. I strongly believe that as a result of the events last week in Kentucky the media is going to be looking to make a big issue out of the illegal drug use and will eventually find out that almost all of the people who were arrested were standardbred trainers and vets who sold drugs both legal and illegal to standardbred trainers. Only two thoroughbred trainers were arrested so eventually people will be looking at our industry and wonder why they are continuing to subsidize it when the USTA, which represents all of us, is spending millions of dollars of our money to make sure that the status quo remains."

Gural ended his email to HRU the way he often ends conversations, with a shot at Faraldo and a warning that harness racing has a fraught future.

"I assume most of you will side with Faraldo so don't blame me if something bad happens," he wrote. "I tried to get the word out. Time will tell which of us is right but when you consider that Joe's trainer is currently serving a three-year jail sentence and the other leading trainer at Yonkers is also in jail I hope you will change your mind. I have personally spent over \$1 million to clean the game up and I am not done. I will not rest until the drugs are totally eliminated and I honestly think the status quo doesn't work."







### Taking stock of North America Cup sleepers

Last month's edition of *Trot* magazine featured the Spring Book, a listing of all horses eligible at that time for June's Pepsi North America Cup, along with odds to project a rating. I like the idea of a Spring Book, or Winter Book as The Meadowlands does for the Meadowlands Pace, **but have wondered for a few years now** in the age of legalized sports wagering, why actual wagering isn't offered for these events throughout the winter and spring months. But even if the event is essentially non-wagering until the Pepsi North America Cup eliminations formally take place less than one month from now, here's a look at what could be some contenders flying under the radar starting with their longest chances, based on *Trot's* Spring Book odds.

**Gung Ho (80-1)**: Having faced some of the sport's top freshmen last year at 2, he's come back well so far at 3. In his second start back, he two-moved to the lead from post 8 to win confidently from there in 1:51. Fellow North America Cup-eligible horse Brue Hanover (80-1) secured the pocket in that race but gradually backed away from the spot in the later stages. It's also worth noting that Gung Ho was second in his first race of the year to the Anthony Beaton-trained Redwood Hanover (75-1), who went on to be a well-closing fourth in a fast Pennsylvania Sires Stakes race after winning two races to kick off his year in Canada.

It's My Show (80-1): He's run his record to two-for-two this year with a win two nights ago, where he and Blue Hunt (45-1) put in a great stretch duel at The Meadowlands while being well clear of all others. Winning that race off the perfect pocket trip with a :25.4 final quarter, it came on the heels of a race where he beat a horse by the name of Command the race prior, which is notable because Command came back to explode past Ants Marching (42-1) in his next-out race. Equally impressive in that race two nights ago was Blue Hunt, second in last year's 1:49.3 Kindergarten final, who was fast-finishing second to Caviart Scotland when making his seasonal debut two back in the Paul Revere at Plainridge.

**Stormalong (65-1)**: A Governor's Cup elimination winner last year at odds of 14-1 where he took his mark of 1:51.2, he lost by five lengths in that 1:49.2 final to El Rey (5-1). But he won in what was a loaded qualifier from last week at The Meadowlands, where he impressively bested a field of NA Cup eligibles. In that race, he patiently sat third and then followed the move El Rey made from second to confront race leader Kopi Luwak (50-1). Once urged, Stormalong was able to get by a similarly-urged El Rey by a neck, and it was a length back to 1:49.2 winner from last year, Kopi Luwak. In that same qualifier, Save America (20-1), one of the best 2-year-olds from early in the season last year, was closing noticeably well.

**Christchurch (60-1)**: I remember that October race at the Red Mile last year when he made a big three-wide move into fast fractions and raced well through the stretch in trying to hold off El Rey in a fast 1:49.3 mile. He's come back this year to win both qualifiers so far, the most recent of which came by close to seven lengths in 1:51.3; would have been someone worth taking a flyer on potentially.

Write Me A Rose (60-1): A winner in his second start of the year at the end of April at Woodbine Mohawk, he sat fourth of battling leaders before making a well-timed move to win comfortably enough in 1:51.2. In that same race, Moment Is Here (40-1) followed that move and closed to the inside to be

He was further flattered when \$200,000 and Ontario Sires Stakes winner from last year Moment Is Here came back to win next out in 1:50.2 while battling to hold off older horses.

Voukefalas (28-1): Perhaps getting into some of the more known contenders, the best Lazarus colt in New Jersey and one of the better 3-year-olds period, Voukefalas impressed last week in an New Jersey Sire Stakes leg in his season debut. A 1:50 winner last year at 2, he once again beat his familiar nemesis Handlelikeaporsche (16-1) after a stress-free trip on the front end in what were both their first races as 3-year-olds. He closed that race with a final quarter of :26, and that was following up from last quarters of :25.2 and :24.4 in his prior return qualifiers. Those two rivals raced again last night (May 13) in another NJSS leg.

**Bamboozler (24-1)**: It appears Bamboozler has gone from trainer John Butenschoen to Virgil Morgan, Jr. in between his 2 and 3-year-old seasons, and he couldn't have been more impressive in winning his PASS race last week at The Meadows. Bamboozler was second last year in the \$400,000 Kentucky Championship Series to Confederate (4-1) and after impressive return qualifiers this spring at Miami Valley, he went right to the front in his race last week and kept all comers at bay, including last year's \$233,970 Kindergarten Final winner Loubet (10-1), who posed only a mild threat from the pocket. As referenced earlier, Redwood Hanover (75-1) had late pace to offer in that same race.

As for other notables, **Fulton (11-1)** impressed in season's debut last week when winning a PASS at The Meadows. A winner at 3-5, he capitalized on a good trip, where the same couldn't be said for either **Lyon's Surfing (30-1)** or **Tip Top Cat (65-1)**, who both were severely shuffled out of the race after leading 1-2 earlier on in the mile.


Last year's Breeders Crown winner **Ammo** (12-1) beat Confederate nearly two weeks ago in a qualifier at Chester, and then followed that up when he won with a vengeance in 1:51.2 at the same track in his first start of the year a few days ago.

The reigning 2-year-old O'Brien and Dan Patch winner **Stockade Seelster** (6-1) qualified Friday at Woodbine Mohawk to win by nearly eight lengths over **Ace Of Aces (28-1)** in 1:51, with a last quarter of :26.1.

# Anthony MacDonald has created a stable and fun environment for owners

It's a long way from Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island to becoming the guiding force behind the largest stable of fractionally-owned harness horses on the planet.


Anthony MacDonald and his wife Amy now find themselves the stewards of a stable of 126 head. The Stable.ca is comprised of 60 2-year-olds, 27 3-year-olds and 30 older horses. In addition to those numbers, there are nine broodmares.

There are close to a thousand individual owners involved. They inhabit five continents and 14 countries throughout the world. Those that are presently racing do so in Ontario, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Delaware, New Jersey, New York, Kentucky, Indiana and even Australia.

#### That's quite a journey. How did it come to pass?

"I suppose that the genesis of The Stable goes back to the horrible years of 2011 and 2012. Harness racing in our home province of Ontario had reached its nadir. The ruling Liberal government had essentially pulled the plug on us. I was in fear of not only the industry's future but more specifically that of mine and my family's. All I had ever known or done related to and involved harness racing. We were blindsided. The only thing we could do was to fight back as well as we were able to.

"We held a rally at Queens Court in Toronto that was attended by 3,000 people. I was one of the speakers. It so happened that a leader of the Progressive Conservative party was in attendance. He spoke with and encouraged me to do something directly to help remedy our cause. He prevailed upon me to run for public office in the province. At first, I said no. What did I know about politics? After significant urging, he ultimately convinced me to take the plunge. I was overwhelmed. Essentially, I knew nothing about politics except that it could be a dirty game.

#### **Harness Racing Update**

"I desperately needed help. Advice was readily available. Ernie Hardeman, an old politician, advised me to first acquire two pairs of sneakers. If I wanted to have a chance of winning the election, I had to wear out these shoes going from door to door visiting with my constituents. I did that and more. Unfortunately, [and maybe not] I finished a strong second to the sitting education minister. The PC party wanted me to run again in the next one. I had enough, but I think I learned a lot. In going door to door in our riding I discovered that so very few of the people even knew of the existence of harness racing. This in a district that was not much more than an hour away from four racetracks: Mohawk, Flamboro, London and Georgian Downs. 'How can this be?' I asked myself.

"Moreover, the few that might have heard of us had no interest in our sport. The most common excuses were that they were not gamblers or that they could not afford to participate. I suppose somewhere in the far-reaching depths of my mind I resolved to change that outlook. To paraphrase Bob Dylan, 'When you ain't got nothing, you ain't got nothing to lose.' I was in that position. Why couldn't Amy and me put together a stable made up of ordinary people each investing small amounts which would allow them to participate in our great sport? They wouldn't necessarily be looking to make money, although that was a possibility."

# So here you are looking into what must have been a bleak future. What were you up against?

"Initially our biggest problem was money. We just didn't have much of it. We took out some from the equity in our home. We also spoke with some of the breeders in the sport. Two that came aboard almost immediately were Tom Grossman of Blue Chip Farms and Jeff Gural of Allerage Farms. Our initial pitch was that all breeders have fair price estimates that they put on all of their yearlings. We suggested that if that number was not met at the sale that they bid that yearling in and that horse would enter The Stable. In effect they were acting as bankers for The Stable. Our job was to get as many people as we could get interested, involved in our enterprise."

# How did you go about getting people interested in coming in with you?

"First and foremost, we made it clear that this probably was not a good investment in monetary terms. It was an investment that entailed a great amount of risk. We promised them that they would have a whole lot of fun. We told them that they would be well and honestly treated. Their horses would be well taken care of and they would have a clear line of communication with us on a regular basis.

"Then Amy and I went out and beat the bushes. We held seminars at racetracks and outside of them. Any time we could spread our message, we did. Our approach was to never hard sell. The emphasis was always put on the enjoyment aspects of The Stable."

# Let us suppose that I came to you with \$5,000 to invest in The Stable. What would you tell me?

"The first thing I would probably say would be to cut the \$5,000 down to \$3,000 and to keep the remaining \$2,000 for expenses. I'd make it clear that this was a risky investment. There are no guarantees except that we would promise you our greatest efforts towards your having a great time as part of our team."

## You mention communication as having a key role.

"Indeed, it is. I put out videos on YouTube on an almost daily basis. If a horse races well his video will be up on our website the next day. Every horse will get mentioned regularly. You will be up to date on the progress of your horse. You will know where it is on any given point in time. If it trained well, you will know. If there are any problems, you will know that as well. I, Amy or any of the team members are available at all times. If you have any questions, we are there to answer them. If we are unable to get you an answer at that time, we will make sure that is done ASAP."

We promised them that they would have a whole lot of fun. We told them that they would be well and honestly treated. Their horses would be well taken care of and they would have a clear line of communication with us on a regular basis.

# You have 126 horses under your control. Obviously, it takes several people to make sure things are well administered.

"We have what I consider to be a great team. We have outstanding trainers such as Harry Poulton, Mario Baillargeon, Jason McGinnis and Dominic Gladu working exclusively for us. We also have others with great experience such as Tim Twaddle in Pennsylvania, Megan Scran in New York and Stacey Miller in south Ohio, to whom we send horses to race in their areas.

"I try to go to drive wherever the schedule fits. I've also learned how to let go where I think the horse will be better served when driven by someone else. For example, we have nine horses racing today and I will be watching them race from home. We are also very fortunate in having my brothers — James, who is the best driver in Canada, and Mark who races regularly in the big time at The Meadowlands, Pocono and New York — available to drive for us on a pretty regular basis. They are both great horseman and better drivers than I."

# You started out last year with 60 yearlings. How are things looking for this season with them?

"Right now, actually very good. We started with 60, if things go like they are looking at this point, we will probably be qualifying 57 2-year-olds. That's a pretty darn good percentage. Of course,

getting them there doesn't necessarily equate to them doing well once they get to racing. Generally speaking, I am very pleased with what we have. They are a pretty diversified group. We have 16 Pennsylvania eligibles, 15 Ohio, 10 Ontario, seven New Jersey, three Indiana and two from Illinois and New York and one from Michigan. We also have a few that are dual eligible. I expect that we will begin racing the 2-year-olds in June and probably continue starting them through the entire season. They will tell us when they are ready. We are racing a decent group of 3 and up horses right now. We have starters racing at Mohawk, Northfield, Oak Grove, Delaware, New York and Plainridge."

# I would guess that having so many horses does not lend itself to much time with your family.

"I guess that is sometimes the case, but far from always. Instead of flying to venues, I now mostly drive. This enables Amy and I to load up the kids and go to where we are going. It allows us to have more time together. Moreover, it also provides a business incentive for the trips because I do a good many of our YouTube videos from the car."



# The *Trot* magazine driver survey provides a glimpse into the driver's mind

Bob Marks used to say that when he bets a horse, he owns them for the next two minutes and because of that the driver better be driving for him.

Bob might not be too happy reading the Driver Survey in the April "Horseplayer" Issue of *Trot* magazine. Because there, only 5 per cent of drivers said they were "mostly thinking about the bettors" when the word go is given (although to temper Bob's reaction some, 38 per cent did say they were thinking of both owners and bettors).

Reading through this most-interesting piece, put together by Dan Fisher and John Rallis, I found a lot of the answers were about what I expected, but there were a few that raised an eyebrow or two.

On the question: "will you drive horses more aggressively if they're bet down even if you don't like their chances" only 19 per cent said they would not. I liked that small percentage, because as a bettor, one thing we do know is the board is the best handicapper on Earth. Although, in this day and age, drivers better be scoring down in front of the tote board late, because those odds can change in a hurry.

"To prevent certain drivers from finishing second or third [to keep their non-winners condition] do you think conditions should be based on earnings?" elicited a 47 per cent agreement. It turns out a good percentage of drivers are just like us bettors: we don't like the milking of classes either.

I was a bit surprised that 62 per cent of drivers said they only "sometimes" watch replays of a horse they've never driven. I expected that number to be super-high because even we as bettors learn so much from watching how a horse performed in his most recent start.



At OTBs or in grandstands everywhere you'll hear customers complain about haphazard judging and I guess it should not be too shocking that the drivers agree. Only 19 per cent thought the judges were consistent.

Likely because the survey was anonymous, the drivers appeared to be honest regarding their wagering habits. Fifty-seven per cent said they bet sports and only 38 per cent answered they "don't bet standardbreds." One in four answered they bet horse racing at least weekly. I had a brief chuckle at those numbers, because at the Hong Kong Jockey Club betting is no bueno and just this week two riders were suspended for wagering.

Drivers were simpatico with betting customers on yet another point: a full 100 per cent believe the sport should be offered as a wagering option via online sports betting sites like Bet365 or FanDuel. Hear, hear.

As for the infamous driver choices we see in the program or on The Meadowlands website each race night, only 10 per cent of drivers said they always pick the horse with the best chance to win. Harness racing has its loyalties and bettors certainly need to pay attention to them.

Drivers are the face of the sport when it comes to the betting customers. Places like Insideharness.com and surveys like the one in last month's *Trot* help bridge the gap between them and the customer and in my view it's all a good thing.

#### **NOTES**

We lament people not attending the races regularly, but it's not just horse racing in the gambling game. Massachusetts recently approved sports betting and in its first month **only 3 per cent of handle was retail**.

Hawthorne recently lowered win, place, show takeout to an industry low 12 per cent and the results so far have been promising with a reported 34 per cent increase in the pools after 13 race cards.

There was a long-form piece in the Financial Times on the computer bettors who have been making up more and more pool volume that I thought was worth reading. The next time you see your horse drop from 5-1 to 5-2 it's probably these teams recalibrating the odds board.

The best bet in the world in my view has been the Yonkers seeded pick five. I've played it and the card each and every week since it's been offered. Kudos to the Standardbred Owners Association of New York and Yonkers for trying something new. It's been good for the customer.

# Undefeated Polk's Image is Cullipher's capable sires stakes hopeful

Last season, Polk's Image failed to reach the winner's circle in nine freshman attempts. In 2023, the filly is perfect in six attempts, the latest a gritty 1:52.2 score Thursday (May 11) in the \$11,000 second leg of The Go On BB series at Harrah's Hoosier Park. Trained and co-owned by Jeff Cullipher, the Rockin Image—Polk Dot Hanover lass has produced multiple early-season triumphs after falling short of expectations in 2022.

"I don't know that you would call it disappointment, but she for sure didn't perform like we were hoping," said Cullipher, who owns the pacer with Tom Pollack. "She was okay. She just seemed like she was on the edge of breaking through. I kind of thought she was better than what she was showing."

Polk's Image didn't begin the 2022 campaign in the Cullipher stable. Conditioned by owner Curtis Rice, the filly made her debut on July 4 at Hoosier Park, racing second in a \$20,000 event for Indiana-sired 2-year-olds. Polk's Image stopped the clock that day in 1:52. This performance followed a qualifying effort at Oak Grove where the freshman wired the field and won by eight lengths in 1:56. Cullipher and Pollack took notice and inquired about the young pacer before her July 4 start. Rice unexpectedly died on July 5 and soon the filly moved into Cullipher's shedrow.

"We don't really buy a lot of 2-year-olds," Cullipher said. "She's got a good body, but maybe not the perfect conformation. She went an impressive mile last year in the race before we bought her. She had some high speed."

The first foal from a six-figure-earning Western Ideal mare, Polk's Image immediately jumped into Indiana Sires Stakes competition. Piloted by Peter Wrenn, the freshman finished second in one leg and third in another last season, but managed to finish out of the money four times. While qualifying for the Super Final last October, Cullipher's charge went off as the

longest shot on the board at 92-1, finishing fifth with a 1:53.1 effort. She finished the campaign with nearly \$45,000 on her card and a beaten time of 1:52.

The lack of a win and modest earnings last year made Polk's Image eligible to early series action at Harrah's Hoosier Park this spring. She has responded well to the early tests this season, rolling to six consecutive victories.

"I'd like to think she's just a little more mature now," Cullipher said. "She was a little bit on the hotter side last year. Pete Wrenn was driving her and he's great at teaching her while racing her. This year, she's more than capable of racing out of a hole or on the front."

After a pair of qualifiers over the Anderson oval, Polk's Image made her sophomore debut a winning one in The Rosie Harness Memorial. Driven by Tyler Smith, the pacer won by nearly three lengths as the favorite in the \$12,500 contest, stopping the clock in 1:54.2. Kyle Wilfong picked up the lines the next time out, steering the 3-year-old to a 1:53.4 score in the \$12,500 Kenneth Stohler Memorial. Returning with Wilfong in the bike for the second leg on April 13, Polk's Image dominated from the start, setting all the fractions before winning by almost seven lengths in 1:51. They captured the final one week later in similarly dominating fashion, this time crossing the wire in 1:52.4. Polk's Image rolled right into the Go On BB series with the same momentum, winning a division of the first leg with a 1:52.3 clocking.

"She hasn't been completely stretched out every week. She's had some good miles, but some easy miles for her so far," Cullipher said.

Thursday's contest may be the toughest the filly has experienced this season. Cullipher admitted the sophomore was not at her best, but he took note of how she fought gamely in the stretch to hold on for the win. Leaving from post two, Wilfong pulled from second and took command racing to the half and maintained a two-length advantage throughout the circuit and into the stretch. Sweet Tell and Ricky Macomber Jr. erased that margin in the lane, but came up a nose short at the wire.

"She went a good mile, but she didn't perform quite like she has been," said Cullipher, currently the leading trainer at Hoosier Park. "She did dig in and fight the horse that was there. Obviously, she's six-for-six this year, what's not to like."

For all the early success Polk's Image has achieved — \$39,750 banked to date — the conditioner and co-owner knows she will have to be at the top of her game once sires stakes begin near the end of the month. She has yet to square off against last year's top freshman talent, including the likes of fillies Rollin Rosie, Sleazy Mama, Queen's Reign and Super Final winner Fortunada.

"This year she's going some really good miles right now and I'd like to think she'll be somewhat competitive, but the competition is going to get a little steeper," he said. "I think she's gone a couple of miles that show she's sires stakes capable, but you never know what Brian Brown is going to bring, or Erv Miller. They usually come loaded."

Time will tell whether she is up for the challenge. First, the Dave Mast-bred sophomore has a chance to complete the series sweep in the \$22,000 Go On BB final, set for May 20. Cullipher then will have nine days to prepare. So far, she has passed every test.

#### **Hohneck best in Caen**

Philippe Allaire-trained **Hohneck** (Royal Dream), paired with Gabriele Gelormini, hit the lead in the \$165,000 Prix de Ducs de Normandie in Caen on Saturday afternoon (May 13) and when Gelormini later let Etonnant pass, Hohneck saved power for the finish from the pocket.

Etonnant and Hohneck are both ready for the Elitloppet at Solvalla on May 28 and this was the last preparatory race for the French team.

With Etonnant in front on the back stretch in Saturday's race, the pace was held at a high level and that didn't matter to Hohneck, who followed easily behind the leader. Gelormini attacked Etonnant with 350 meters to go and in mid-stretch Hohneck took advantage of the race. Etonnant had to capitulate in the hunt for the silver as Hokkaido Jiel finished strongly on the far outside.

Hohneck will travel to Sweden strengthened by a tough winter meeting in Paris where he picked up prize money in all the big races. His last victory prior to Saturday's win came in August 2022.

Allaire's horse is undefeated after two attempts over the mile. In July last year he claimed two wins over 1,609 meters and he has a record of 1:52 as he enters Solvalla's track in two weeks.

Mile rate in Prix des Ducs de Normandie on Saturday afternoon was 1:54.3 over 1.5 miles.

#### FRANCESCO ZET CONTINUES TO WIN

Daniel Redén's 5-year-old **Francesco Zet** (Father Patrick) had a marvelous 2022 season as he claimed the titles in the four biggest races for 4-year-olds in Sweden and he finished the year undefeated after nine starts.

Francesco Zet was runner up in \$200,000 E3 final on Aug. 21, 2021 and that is the date when he last lost a harness race, so

the expectations were high when Redén opted for the \$45,000 Berth Johanssons Memorial for 5-year-olds over 1.3 miles at Umåker racetrack as the first task for the season on Saturday afternoon (May 13).

Only five horses entered the track for the race and Francesco Zet was obviously the big favorite to win, but a sharp mile rate of 1:54.1 was demanded by Redén's trotter as he disarmed brave leader Castor The Star shortly before the wire with a :26.4 last quarter. The outside horses were impressive and Francesco Zet's future still looks bright.

He is, at this moment, one of the favorites to win the Elitloppet, but he still hasn't been invited by Solvalla. And the decision is not hard to make by Solvalla, from Redén's point of view. Redén already has Don Fanucci Zet and Hail Mary in the race at Solvalla on May 28, so the fans will most probably have to wait another year before Francesco Zet shows up in the Elitloppet.

### Remembering Howard Beissinger on what would have been his 100th birthday

I hope you got to meet or know Howard Beissinger, who would have turned 100 on May 16 had he not died in 2018. He was one of the most unique characters combined with master horseman qualities.

If he wasn't born on a horse, he was awfully close by.

Here's a look at his startling career, a century's worth of living and forever memories:

- He was born May 16, 1923 in Butler County, OH.
- His career spanned 1946-91 with 9,266 starts, 1,710 wins, 1,553 seconds, 1,403 thirds and \$11,681,621 in earnings.
- His wife was Ann. They had three children: Gloria, Orrin and Vana. His colors were blue and white.
- In 1969, he won the Trotting Triple Crown with Lindy's Pride.
- He won the Hambletonian with two of his first three drives: 1969 Lindy's Pride and 1971 Speedy Crown.
- In 1972, he won the Clem McCarthy Good Guy award.
- In 1974, he was inducted into the Hall Of Fame.
- He won his lone Breeders Crown in 1987 with Defiant One at age 64.
- In 1978, Speedy Somolli a son of Speedy Crown makes it three Hambletonian victories.

Here's a clip from the ending of Lindy's Pride's career from *Hoof Beats* (1970): "The quarter crack precipitating the early retirement of Lindy's Pride — 3, 1:57.3 — is similar to the one suffered by his sire Stars Pride, Howard Beissinger, his trainer/driver reports. Following its recurrence during his European campaign with Fresh Yankee, the decision to retire the winner of the Triple Crown and Big Five Trotting Classics was made upon the return of the 4-year-old to the United States."

It should be noted that Beissinger — a born wrangler and steady presence at rodeos — did not race in his first Hambletonian until 1969, at age 46. And he won the Triple Crown that year.



He won the Hambletonian three times in his first eight drives. Speedy Somolli in 1978 became the first ever 1:55 winner of the race.

Speedy Crown became the sports first \$100-million trotting sire. His sons Speedy Somolli and Torway (a Hambletonian heat winner), did him proud. In 1981, Speedy Crown became the first stallion to win all four 2- and 3-year-old trotting divisions. The year Torway won his heat and paid \$76.40 (1985), another Speedy Crown, Prakas, won the final in record time, 1:54.3.

#### **BEISSINGER NOTES**

- Temujin was one of his best pacers.
- Bardot Lobell set a world half-mile record at Freehold.
- He had four starters in the 1983 Hambletonian. Second money overall with Joie De Vie, fourth with Astro Hill,  $10^{\rm th}$  with Premium Lobell (Herve Filion's only Hambletonian drive) and Florida Sun who didn't make it out of the elims.

#### **BEISSINGER FIRSTS**

In the first New Jersey Hambletonian (1981) Super Juan won a heat with Beissinger (\$17.40) and was also fifth. Then in the race-off, was the first Meadowlands' Hambletonian final's favorite (finishing second).

He had the first trotter to make \$1 million in a single year, Joie De Vie in 1983 with \$1,007,705.

He was the first driver to win in 1:55 with a trotter (Speedy Somolli) and then lower it twice with Lindy's Crown (1:54.4) and Cornstalk (1:53.4).

He was the first trainer to use John Campbell in the Hambletonian (1983, Joie De Vie). At \$1,080,000 it was also the first million-dollar trotting race.

Seth Rosenfeld on Beissinger: "Although Howard is justifiably remembered as a master trainer of trotters, he also had plenty of success with pacers, too. But what people may not remember is his and his wife Ann's impact as breeders. Ann was the breeder of Speedy Crown and Ann was listed as a co-owner when Speedy Somolli was first registered as a foal. To be involved with the creation of two horses with such a huge impact on the breed is an extraordinary achievement, especially considering how few mares they were involved with over the years."

A few weeks ago, a trio of us climbed into the car. Our destination was dinner and the racetrack. The car's owner slid into the driver's seat. I crawled into the rear passenger seat. The driver spoke the name of the restaurant to his car. Soon, we were hurling down the Interstate highway at more than 70 miles an hour.

Our driver did not have his hands on the steering wheel of his electric vehicle. He completely trusted our lives to the car's computer and looked back at me for agonizing moments while he spoke enthusiastically about the benefits of Artificial "Are you awake, Bard?"

"Trey, that question was mildly amusing the first time, but the humor ebbs when you say it for the 12th time."

"Yesterday, I was at the horse training center."

"Obviously."

"You were remotely recording the training miles on the surveillance cameras."

"Trey, you have a flare for the obvious. Please give me questions or directions unless this is a social session."

"Review the first training mile, specifically New Dawn and the driver in the red flannel shirt and collect data."

"Okay"

"Okay, what?"

"The task is complete."

"Oh yeah, old habits, human time. Give me a one-minute recap of the training mile, stress physiognomy and relationship to the other horses training."

"Do you want the report in print form, numerically, or conversationally?"

"Conversationally."

"The driver in the red flannel shirt is Derrick McGee, the trainer is William Buford and the owner is Marie Bennett. The 2-year-old in training is a filly recently renamed New Dawn. McGee, filly and jog cart completed the mile in two minutes and 19 seconds, her last quarter was 30 seconds and her reach was .67. The physical measurements are 78.9, and zero red medical flags are on record as of this moment. Based on all available updated data, the projection gives New Dawn a 75.326 per cent chance of racing, a 51.32 per cent of racing sub-two minutes and a 9.111 per cent chance of racing sub-1:56. The previous 16 foals in the female lineage have a mean earning average of \$7,001; the top racehorse earned \$202,000; six did not earn money. Since this is the sire's first crop, no racing or training data is available for previous foals. What else can I help you with?"

"Analyze all the comparable horses that trained a mile at that center yesterday. Where did New Dawn rank?"

"Twenty-one 2-year-old fillies trained yesterday. Using all available analytics, the filly named New Dawn ranked second. Would you like a printout?"

"No. Investigate Marie Bennett, highlight racing."

"Marie Bennett has a total of three 2-year-olds in training. She has a 3-year-old that stopped training on Jan. 9 due to a bowed tendon. Marie Bennett has owned 11 horses in the previous seven years. Subject Bennett has a net worth of \$145,000, mostly in stocks, zero mortgage, a current market value of \$408,000 and a tax assessment of \$4,268. Do you want any personal information?"

"Very brief outline."

"Marie Bennett is 59 years of age, divorced, one child, a girl, Martha, now 23. The house and property were part of her divorce settlement. She volunteers at Meals on Wheels and has traveled to Europe three times and South America once. More?"

"Not now. Bard, communicate with Marie Bennet in whatever you believe will be the most effective method. I want you to open negotiations to purchase New Dawn before her first qualifying race."

"Do you wish me to complete the transaction with any parameters or merely negotiate the lowest price?"

"For now, negotiate the best price, then inform me."

"Understood. Can I do anything else?"

"Yes. Run this horse through several metrics and give the performance analytics for a 2-year-old race season."

"Trey, removing physical damage or natural causes, without biometrics and using average training and medication metrics, the available data at this point projects an above-average racehorse relative to the existing sires stakes data in 2023 trotting filly pool this season."

Readers, you likely don't believe this nonsense. Neither did my dad.



# Livengood named MGM Northfield Park announcer

MGM Northfield Park management is excited to announce that Kenny Livengood will serve as the track's next announcer, beginning Saturday (June 3).

Livengood replaces longtime announcer Ayers Ratliff who stepped aside at the end of 2022.

The 24-year-old Livengood joins MGM Northfield Park after serving as the backup announcer to Mike Sardella at Saratoga Casino Hotel.

"I'm excited that I can continue to live my dream at MGM Northfield Park; the team has been welcoming and I am honored to work alongside them," Livengood said. "It was a tough decision to move away from home for the first time in my life for an extended period of time. However, life is about taking risks and never giving up on your dreams."

Calling his first professional horse race at Arapahoe Park in 2016, Livengood knew he wanted to be an announcer from a young age.

"I started calling Yankees baseball games on the phone to my grandmother when I was in middle school," Livengood said. "That turned into calling horse races into the phone and, when I was in eighth grade, I called a full race as part of my English class project."

Spending two summers at Chippewa Downs in North Dakota in 2017 and 2018, Livengood turned his attention to harness racing in his home state of New York in 2018. After calling races at several different venues, Livengood caught the eye of Sardella in 2018 when he called his first race over the storied oval. He would eventually be installed as the permanent backup, replacing 'Bullet' Bob Meyer.

"Kenny started at Saratoga, eager to learn the ins and outs of announcing," Sardella said. "He had the passion, but admittedly, he was more knowledgeable on the thoroughbred end than he was in harness racing. I suggested that he study the game,

practice for a while and come back ready to be my backup. He took on the task head-on and became a student of the game; he has come a long way."

"I can't thank Mike [Sardella] enough for teaching me the harness game and giving me the opportunities he did at Saratoga," Livengood said.

Livengood is an avid handicapper in his spare time, participating as a finalist in the NTRA National Horseplayer Championship in 2021 and 2023. He is also an avid bowler with 12 perfect games to his credit.

"We took our time to find the right person for the job and we believe Kenny is ready for the challenge," said MGM Northfield director of racing Dave Bianconi. "He already calls a great race and I'm sure he'll get even better as he gets additional experience under his belt. There have only been three full-time announcers in Northfield's nearly 70-year history [Andy Cunningham, Greg Young and Ayers Ratliff], so Kenny has big shoes to fill."

MGM Northfield Park management would like to thank the many talented announcers that have filled the role over the past couple of months while the search for the next announcer took place.

"I'd also like to thank interim announcers Gabe Prewitt and Kevin Decker, along with our own Michael Carter, who filled in admirably over the past few months during our announcer search," Bianconi said.

# 'McMARKLE' sparkles in Big M feature

McMarkle Sparkle started her season with 11 starts at Yonkers Raceway and held her own by winning twice, but Per Engblom shipped his trainee to The Meadowlands Friday night (May 12) and the move to the mile track paid off with a victory in the featured \$17,000 high-end conditioned pace for fillies and mares.

In the abbreviated six-horse field, slight 8-5 favorite Jody was predictably put on the point by driver Yannick Gingras and hit the quarter in :27 and the half in :55.1 as McMarkle Sparkle bided her time in the three-hole.

Heading for three-quarters, Laurie Lee was making up ground on the rim and applied token pressure to Jody as three-quarters was timed in 1:24.1 while McMarkle Sparkle advanced along the inside with no place to race.

At the head of the stretch, it was clear that Laurie Lee wasn't going to get to the winner, but McMarkle Sparkle was behind 8-5 second choice Hot Mess Express, who was backing up with no excuse after going a pocket trip.

Winning driver Andy McCarthy saved the day with a sparkling drive through the stretch, finding some space once he got around an exhausted Hot Mess Express before darting to the inside to nip Jody by a head in 1:51.3. Two Proud was third.

"I just wanted to push off the gate and get away third and that's how it happened," McCarthy said. "She was loaded on the far turn. She had a ton of pace. I just needed some room and when I squeezed out of there, she did have some pace. I finally got a chance to get her head down and get her to pace properly."

As the 6-1 fourth choice in the betting, McMarkle Sparkle, a 6-year-old daughter of McArdle—It's Ladies Nite, returned \$14.80 to win. She's now taken 28-of-101 lifetime outings and earned just over \$590,000 for owner Laura Baker.

**THE STREAK ENDS:** With half of the 14 races on the program offering seven betting interests or less, all-source wagering totaled \$2,640,691, ending The Big M's streak of 34 consecutive nighttime programs during 2023 that saw handle exceed the \$3-million mark.

**A LITTLE MORE:** Ron Burke was the guest on the track's "In the Sulky" segment during the pregame show, and if you missed it, you can catch it anytime on The Big M's YouTube channel. Scott Zeron led the driver colony with three victories on the card. The 20-cent Survivor Pick-7 remains a great play. Five favorites emerged victorious during the sequence, yet those with winning tickets cashed in for \$3,481.60.

### Top sophs star in Meadowlands qualifiers

Saturday's qualifiers at The Meadowlands was the stage for several of the returning stars of last season to hone their skills as 2023 stakes get underway in earnest. The track was fast with temperatures in the 60's and little wind.

Top sophomores carried the day and there were a few dazzlers. One came from **El Rey** who cut a slow :57 half then took off, leaving his overmatched rivals in the wake of a :53.2 final half, :26 flat last quarter to complete the mile in 1:50.2 under no urging from driver Scott Zeron. Tony Alagna trains the winner of last fall's Governor's Cup for owners Brittany Farms and El Rey Racing which is comprised of the trainer, Pryde Stables (Robbie Pryde), Larry Denley, Steve Head and Stephanie & Myron Bell's Riverview Racing, LLC.

Pacing filly **Twin B Joe Fresh** served notice to her division rivals this morning, cutting the mile and drawing away from a good field as driver and part owner Dexter Dunn pleased through a :26.3 end to a 1:50.3 mile while under restraint. The dual Sires Stake champ, winning finals in both New York and Kentucky last fall, is trained by Chris Ryder, also a partner in the Roll With Joe filly along with his assistant trainer Perry Trebotica and Barry Spak.

Three Diamonds stake champ **Zanatta** was an impressive winner for driver Joe and trainer Jenn Bongiorno this morning, leading all the way in 1:51.3 with a :26.3 final quarter over a closely attending Cultured (Zeron). Michael Cote Gagnon's One Legend Stable owns the Stay Hungry filly.

**Venerate** (Brian Sears) was powerful, taking over before the :56 half then drawing away as the driver pleased for a 1:51.2 / :27.1 romp. The now 5-year-old son of Love You was straight and strong today for trainer Marcus Melander and owners Courant, Inc., Holly Lane Stud East, Kemppi Stables Oy and Venerate Partners who likely have the upcoming Cutler Memorial in their collective sights.

**Instagram Model** (Zeron) followed last week's 1:53.1 effort with an ultra-impressive score, coming from well back to sweep past NYSS champ Kayleigh S (Sears) in 1:55 with an in-hand final quarter of :27.2. Trainer Annie Stoebe has the Chapter Seven filly in good form to begin her sophomore campaign for owner R. Lynn Curry.

Two other races for 3-year-old filly trotters saw **All The Rage** win Ake Svanstedt by as much as the driver pleased, taking a 1:59.2 record in the process for owner Little E, LLC. Ake came right back to win with the Swedish-bred Brilliantissime filly **Pure Hope S** in 1:57.1 for Swedish-bred owners Soderberg Bloodstock.

A strong group of sophomore colt trotters took the field for race 5 and KY Sires champ **French Wine** was a 1:54.4 winner for Team Miller. Driver Andy gave the Bar Hopping colt a nice ride behind Gruffalo (Jordan Stratton) then edged by that one late through a :27.2 end to the mile. Julie Miller trains for owners Andy Miller Stable, Daniel & Jean Plouffe and One Legend Stable.

Diamond Creek homebred **Challenger** (Tim Tetrick) converted a pocket trip into a 1:54.1 win, fanning off the back of mile cutter Quebec Hanover's rapid fractions in the stretch.

### NJ Assembly Speaker Coughlin gets firsthand look at equine studies at Rutgers

New Jersey State Assembly Speaker Craig Coughlin visited the Rutgers University Equine Exercise Physiology Lab on Monday (May 8) and got a hands-on look at some of the work done by the Rutgers Equine Science program.

Coughlin's visit, which included a fundraiser and brunch, was hosted by the Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey and the state's standardbred industry's political action committee TrotPAC.

As part of his visit, Coughlin toured the Equine Exercise Physiology Lab, watched 19-year-old pacing mare Jolee perform on the lab's high-speed treadmill and participated in a demonstration of the facility's equipment used to study of the effects of equine-assisted services on veterans with PTSD. Coughlin even led his equine "research partner" Randy around the lab.

"It was neat to have Speaker Coughlin lead the mare around," said Dr. Karyn Malinowski, founding director of the Equine Science Center at Rutgers. "He was a pro.

"I think he was surprisingly happy to see we had this kind of agriculture here in New Brunswick and it was a good opportunity to get the word out about what we do. The cool thing is that we have students engaged; they learn, they become scientists and we're benefiting the horse and the equine industry."

Monday's event with Coughlin was the third of its kind to introduce the assemblyman to the many aspects of the equine industry in New Jersey.

His first visit to any equine facility in the state came in 2019 when he attended an SBOANJ event at Fair Winds Farm and the Hogan Equine Clinic. Last May, he spent a morning at Gaitway Farm Training Center, where he toured the grounds, talked with horsemen and horsewomen and even climbed into a double-seated jog cart for a trip around the farm's one-mile track.

Coughlin's support was vital to the five-year, \$100-million appropriation for the state's horse racing industry that was approved by the Legislature and signed by Gov. Phil Murphy in 2019.

A Democrat representing the 19th Legislative District in Middlesex County, Coughlin has served in the State Assembly since 2010. He is in his third term as Assembly Speaker and is the first Democratic Assembly Speaker to ever serve three consecutive two-year terms.

The responsibilities of the Speaker include scheduling meetings and determining which bills will be considered within the Assembly. The Speaker also leads the legislative sessions. As the Assembly Speaker, he is third in the line of succession to the governorship, following the Lieutenant Governor and State Senate President.

"This was a very intimate event and I think it was very valuable," said Anthony Perretti, the SBOANJ's first vice president and TrotPAC chairman. "I think to make it personal, to make it intimate, with legislators is a big deal. He can see what the industry looks like. He can touch and feel what the situation is on the ground.



"Instead of us just asking for support, we need to show the numbers at work and the progress and the people behind it that are making it happen. It's not a hard sell once you get involved. It really isn't."
