What I would do if I were standing Dan Patch champion Monte Miki.

One of Debbie Harry's best lyrics is Dreaming Is Free. Applying it literally to myself, indulge me when I fantasize that I have miraculously found that I'm now the owner of the champion pacing colt Monte Miki.

For those with short or even shorter memories, i.e. less than a week of function, Monte Miki was the champion 2-year-old pacing colt of 2021. He won the Breeders Crown and the Metro, and was only beaten once all season, and that in a photo (click here).

For me, and the greatest thoroughbred breeder of all time, Federico Tesio, the 2-year-old racing season is the definitive time that accurately predicts a stallion's sire potential.

Parenthetically, recently one of the major breeders in our sport, and highly successful, told me he hadn't bred to Walner because he hadn't come on and raced successfully as a 3-year-old.

I know when to keep my mouth shut, at least part of the time, so I said nothing. Of course to the small but hardy band of Leavitt-Tesio believers, Walner is to us the perfect proof of our belief in 2-year-old brilliance.

Again, for those with short memories, Walner was untouchable at 2. I haven't looked up his lines, but I doubt he was ever headed. Linda Toscano wrote her name indelibly in the history of our sport by training this great horse to an unbroken record at 2, and then had the wisdom, and the courage, not to take any

chance of blemishing his name by bringing him back for a full season at 3 when she knew he was just a hair off. A lot of other people would have doctored him up and gone back to the track with him, but Ms. Toscano, in Kenny Roger's words, knew when to hold 'em and when to fold 'em. That's why she well deserves her place in the Hall of Fame.

Back, however, to Monte Miki, a great future sire prospect, whom I am lucky enough now to "own", thanks to Debbie Harry of Blondie fame. In case you forgot, Monte Miki was retired from training three weeks ago after he suffered a tear in his tendon sheath.

#### **Harness Racing Update**

So Debbie Harry notwithstanding, I didn't get to race Monte Miki this year at 3, and I've now got him home at my farm.

First thing would be to have Dr. Larry Bramlage check him over and make sure we were taking the right care of that tendon sheath. Meanwhile, we'd be turning him out every day, assuming Dr. Bramlage says it's alright to. He'd be in a medium-sized lot with good grass, a water fountain, and rounded, not square corners. Too many horses hurt themselves when they jam themselves down running into a fence in a square corner.

His stall would be the size of two regular stalls, and there'd be a section of each side wall that was barred, not solid, so he could get friendly with each of the mares on either side of him. Same principle when he's turned out. There would be an eight foot aisle all the way around his paddock, and there would be mares, several of them, always in even numbers, in the neighboring pastures. There wouldn't be another stallion within sound or sight of M², ever.

After Dr. B. gives the green light to breaking our horse to breed, he'd enter the breeding shed. There would be an open mare in the tease stall, one who was red hot in season. We'd let him tease her until he finally got the idea, and, euphemistically, "dropped down."

Then he'd be led over to the breeding dummy, or, technically, Phantom Mare. This is one of the great inventions of the modern horse breeding industry, and it is used for many breeds besides ours, including Morgans, Arabians, Quarter Horses, and Saddle Horses. Every breed in North America, actually, except for the thoroughbred.

The Phantom Mare, without which there couldn't be commercial artificial insemination, was invented by one of the greatest vets who ever lived, Dr. Wendell Cooper. Dr. Cooper worked for me at one time, in the days before semen transport was sanctified by the USTA. One season I gave him 37 mares to breed to Speedy Crown, and by June 25 every one of them was in foal.

Since Debbie Harry has allowed me to have everything the best in our breeding shed, our breeding dummy is adjustable as to height. The trick here is to have the stallion hit the dummy with his chest at approximately the same height as an actual mare's behind. In case our new pupil, in this case Monte Miki, sill doesn't quite catch on, we'll walk the tease mare up beside the dummy, but when he jumps to mount, we'll keep his body and his head pointed at the dummy.

Once he's mounted, my manager, Keith Cox, a top horseman, will appear with the aptly named Artificial Vagina, get M2's willy inside it, and that's where he'll ejaculate.

We'll do this routine every other day for a week, then give him three days off and then collect him twice, on the fourth day, within the same hour. From that second collection, the great equine repro specialist, Dr. Karen Wolfsdorf will analyze his semen and then we'll know exactly how much we have to work with.

Another point, in passing. Many stallion deals include a condition that calls for a fertility test before the deal is closed. That isn't really necessary. A skilled repro vet can take certain crucial testicular

measurements, put them into an equation, and the result will tell with 95 per cent accuracy what that horse's semen output will be.

It doesn't, of course, tell you what the semen quality is, but it does give you the most important number in evaluating a stallion's breeding potential. And it eliminates the necessity of actually breeding the horse, which can't be done during the racing season.

So that's my rendition of Dreaming Is Free, and I think I did it pretty well considering I'm not a professional singer. And if whoever actually owns Monte Miki ever feels like a duet, I'll be happy to sing along with him anytime he calls, lyrics courtesy of Debbie Harry.

\$4,000 purchase giving Ohio owner/trainer Roger Hughes, Jr. a wonderful ride

Resilient trotter Sultan Of Cash has earned nearly \$225,000 lifetime in Ohio.

Ohio-based owner/trainer Roger Hughes, Jr. was just looking for one more horse to complete his stable. What he found was 'resilient' trotter Sultan Of Cash who has overcome soundness issues to earn nearly \$225,000.


The now 7-year-old gelded son of Cash Hall recently established a new lifetime mark of 1:54.3 (May 1 at Miami Valley Raceway) and once again proved the toughness of the standardbred breed.

Hughes was looking for a trotting colt in the fall of 2016 to round out his yearling purchases. It was at the November Blooded Horse Sale that Hughes came across hip #224 – the seventh foal from the unraced Conway Hall mare, Anything But Love.

"I had already purchased a trotting colt and a pacing colt earlier that fall," said Hughes. "I couldn't make it to the sale, so I called a friend and ask if he would look at him for me. He thought he was put together nicely and he would probably bring good money.

"I had a budget of what I wanted to spend, so I gave him a number to bid to. I was watching him sell on my computer at work and he only brought \$4,000.

"He was very head strong, at times, when we trained him down, but made minimal mistakes. We trained him down with the other colts that was purchased and he clearly was a standout."

As a 2-year-old, Sultan Of Cash, who was known as 'Johnny' around the barn, started his season with impressive wins at the Pickaway and Putnam County Fairs with Hughes in the bike.

"I was getting calls from people wanting to buy him," said Hughes. "I turn them down because I wanted to race him a few starts."

Hughes and Sultan Of Cash would then turn their attention to the Ohio Sire Stakes program.

With the larger stage, Hughes was presented with his first problem – who would drive Johnny?

"I didn't have my "P" license," said Hughes. "So, I contacted Ronnie Wrenn, Jr. to see if he would drive him. (Ronnie) looked him up and got back to me and said, 'Yes, for sure."

The first OHSS leg at MGM Northfield Park, Wrenn gave him a perfect pocket sitting trip to score a one-length victory in 1:59.3.

The pair's next two starts came at Eldorado Scioto Downs in the second OHSS leg and the Ohio State Fair Stakes – both wins, the fastest in 1:57.1.

Again, the phone calls and offers started to come Hughes' way.

"This time it was a very difficult decision to make because of the dollar amounts being discussed," said Hughes. "I talked it over and decided to keep him and continue on the great ride we were having."

The third sires stake leg was a gate-to-wire win in another sub 2:00 effort.


Three Ohio Sires Stakes Legs, three victories.

Sultan Of Cash missed the final OHSS leg at Northfield Park due to sickness.

He recovered in time for the \$250,000 Ohio Sires Stake Final on Labor Day weekend at Scioto Downs. Sent off as the betting favorite, the undefeated Sultan Of Cash would finish fourth in the rich final – 3 ¼ lengths behind the future world champion and millionaire, Mission Accepted.

After a solid win in the \$42,000 Ohio Breeders Championship at the Delaware County Fair, Johnny was shut down for the year with seven wins in eight starts and \$126,515 in earnings.

Johnny's sophomore season was supposed to be full of promise, but that is when soundness issues started to appear.

A ho-hum qualifying effort was followed up with a trio of second place finishes in the James Hackett Memorial (elimination and final) and the Scarlet and Gray Invitational at Miami Valley Raceway.

"I had several different vets go over and work on him and he still just wasn't 100 per cent," said Hughes. "He would get steppy late in the mile, so we continued to try and find what the issue was. We took him to Ohio State (University) to have scans ran and they found a couple of hot spots, so we had them worked on."

Sultan Of Cash won the opening leg of the Ohio Sire Stakes and was a game third in the second OHSS leg a month later at Eldorado Scioto Downs.

Despite those solid performances, Hughes knew things with his colt weren't right.

"I had another vet look him over and they didn't find much, maybe a hind ankle bothering him," said Hughes. "So, we injected his ankle and raced him at the Putnam County Fair where he won, but he still just wasn't right."

A couple of days after that win, his injected ankle swelled back up, warranting a return trip to OSU's Galbreath Equine Center.

"They conducted several procedures and tried different types of antibiotics, but it just wasn't taking care of the infection," said Hughes. "They finally got the infection under control and decided they had to go in and take part of his sesamoid bone – taking part of it from each side and part of the tendon with it.

"There was a discussion that it might be in his best interest to euthanize him. I wanted to do what I could to save him, even if that meant he would just become a pasture pet."

Sultan Of Cash spent nearly a month at OSU.

"We would walk him up and down the barn to get him to move," said Hughes. "Once the cast was removed, we started walking him around the fairgrounds, further and further each week."

Johnny was turned out to give his ankle ample time to heal.

Hughes brought Sultan Of Cash back in April 2020 to start his long road back to the races.

"We started out very slow to build up his muscle tone and just continued from there. We started training him and everything seemed to be going well. He was training down nicely and not getting sored up."

The two-year comeback was complete when Sultan Of Cash was entered in the \$4,980 Signature Series event at the Mercer County Fair on August 16, 2020 – a third place finish in 2:02.

"We tried an overnight race (at Hollywood Dayton Raceway), but he was interfered with," said Hughes.

"We decided to turn him out again for a few months and bring him back to race around the fairs."

His 6-year-old season started in the \$900 open trot at the Pickaway County Fair.

Hughes originally asked his sister, Michelle Caldwell, to drive but she ended up giving the duty to Jeremy Smith. Smith steered Johnny to a 15-length win in 2:04.1.

"That was a very good day," said Hughes. "He was never supposed to race again. We continued to make (fair) starts with him through the summer, picking up checks and another win along the way (Shelby County Fair with Michelle in the bike)."


Sultan Of Cash would finish the season racing his way through conditioned events to the \$28,000 open trot at Dayton Raceway, establishing a new lifetime mark of 1:55.2.

This season, Sultan Of Cash has made six starts, missing the board just once. He has earned more than \$21,000 and lowered his career mark to 1:54.3.

"I'm grateful to Allen Woolums, who helped me train and gate him, Michelle (Caldwell) and the staff at OSU," said Hughes. "Their work and dedication were great."

"This story goes to show you how resilient the standard breed is. These horses can overcome a lot of adversity if given the chance," said Hughes. "This horse has been a very special horse for my family and myself. For me, I'm sure there will never be another one like him."







## Kate Gath heading to the U.S. to race for Tilly

Australian harness racing's poster girl Kate Gath is heading to the U.S. to race.

While driving in some harness races is not out of the question, it is Gath's other love, running, which will take her across the world to contest the New York Marathon in November.

The "remarkable opportunity," as Gath describes it, came through her association with star Down Under pacing mare Tough Tilly and her owners, who race the now 4-year-old to raise funds and awareness for EB Research. (Click here)

It's become a cause very close to Gath's heart.

EB, or Epidermolysis Bullosa, is a rare, devastating and life-threatening set of genetic skin disorders.

Pearl Jam frontman Eddie Vedder is a co-founder of the EB Research Partnership.

Tough Tilly is named after Tilly Wilkes, the daughter of partowner Corey Wilkes. Tilly, who suffers from EB, has become the face of Tough Tilly and the greater EB cause in Australia.

And Gath has become very close with Tilly.

"She's gorgeous. She's such a special person and to be part of the whole Tough Tilly ride with Tilly, her family and all the other great people involved in the ownership group is one of the best things I've been involved in," Gath said.

Tough Tilly is a star and, like her human namesake, brave as well.

The daughter of Captaintreacherous has raced just 23 times for 11 wins, seven seconds and a third. She's banked \$A467,633.

And she's just turned 4.

Last Saturday (May 7), Tough Tilly won at the top level (Group 1) for the third time. Perhaps more significantly, she beat Australia's champion mare and her own stablemate Ladies In Red, for the second time in a Group 1 final.

She won on her merits, too. Tough Tilly sat parked (outside the leader) throughout and still held-off Ladies In Red, who stormed home from midfield, to win by a neck.

As if beating Ladies In Red again wasn't big enough, the win was even more special for Gath, trainers Emma Stewart and Clayton Tonkin and all the owners because Tough Tilly has overcome some issues over the past 12 months, including a breathing operation.

"It's up with the most special moments I've had in the game," Gath said. "I didn't think it could get much better than when Tough Tilly upset Ladies In Red about a year-and-a-half ago in the Vicbred final, but for her to come back from her setbacks and do it again... it was just amazing.

"You always wonder if they'll come back as well, but she felt great in her last trial before resuming, then hit the line full of running in the heat without having any luck at all behind Ladies In Red.

"She just gave me such a great feel, I honestly thought we could beat Ladies In Red if we had some luck. She did it the hard way and still beat her.

"It meant so much to me but seeing how much it meant to everyone involved and knowing the money she's raising for EB and the fact she's getting people talking about it and learning about it is such a great thing."

And that's why Gath, who admits the thought of running the New York Marathon is "scary as hell", eventually couldn't say no when the EB team asked if she would run in an ambassadorial slot they have in the great race.

"I love running, absolutely love it. It's my time, my escape from everything," she said. "But I've only run one marathon and that was last December in Melbourne," Gath said.

"To go to the other side of the world in one of the great marathons for my second sounds a bit crazy."

But Gath's initial response when offered the slot was to politely decline.

"I couldn't believe it when they asked if I'd do it, but when I heard what time of year it was – in the middle of our big races – I just didn't think I could do it," she said.

"I told my sisters (Kirby and Courtney), and they were all over me, saying I had to do it. Then my close friend Maree (Caldow) wouldn't hear of me knocking back the opportunity.


"They really convinced me it was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity and one I had to grab.

"I've never been to New York and it's the one place on the planet I've always wanted to visit. So, to go and see it and run the marathon as part of that will be incredible.

"I've since spoken to Jonathon Brown (former Aussie Rules football star), who ran as the EB ambassador a few years ago. He said it was one of the great experiences of his life, which got me even more excited."

Gath ran the Melbourne Marathon in a tick under 3 hrs 24 mins and, remarkably, hopes to break three hours in New York.

She's enlisted a running "coach" to steer her preparation.



"I trained myself for Melbourne and didn't really know what I was doing. I have to get serious for this one, especially if I want to get my time right down," she said.

"I've only had the coach for a couple of weeks and am already noticing a big difference. I've been doing interval training, running short stints quicker than I'd ever do myself, and when I go back to my 'cruising' speed, it seems so much easier."

The remarkable thing is how and when Gath finds the time to do the enormous amount of training around her horse training and race driving commitments.

Gath and her husband, Andy, won the Victorian Metropolitan training title last year and have anywhere between 40 and 50 horses in training at a time.

Outside of that, Gath, who has won more Group 1 races than any other Down Under female, drives at four or five race meetings each week, plus the trials when required.

"I just make time. It's a priority. Whether I have to get up and run really early, do it in the middle of the day, or get home from the races and put the runners on and go out at night, I just have to make it happen," she said.

Gath is renowned for packing her running gear in the car and throwing it on to smash out a few kilometres if she has a break in between races at a race meeting.

Let's hope she packs her driving kit as well as her running gear when she heads to the Big Apple later this year so you can see both sides of this remarkable woman.





## Just A Gigolo is hard to beat

Philippe Allaire-trained **Just A Gigolo** (Boccador de Simm) continues to establish his position as number one in the French "J-crop", the 3-year-old colts and paired with Franck Nivard, the charismatic trotter played with the opponents in Vincennes' \$125,000 Prix Paul Karle on Friday (May 13) night.

Just A Gigolo was positioned second over after 500 meters, but when three quarters of a mile remained in the 1.6 miles long race, Nivard pushed his horse to the lead and then the game was over.

Just A Gigolo is pleasant to watch on a racetrack and he seems to have several abilities that's required to become a top trotter. There's no doubt that he already is a star in France, but it's not easy to take the steps that's needed to be competitive among older trotters in the future. The son of Boccador de Simm landed a 1:59 mile rate over 2,700 meters and Franck Nivard must have had a nice trip behind Philippe Allaire's horse.

This was Just A Gigolo's 8th win in his 10th attempt and the future looks bright for the entourage around the good looking 3-year-old.

First choice and the crop's dominant **Jazzy Perrine** (Django Riff) jogged three wide throughout the first turn and on the stretch ahead of the grandstand while the pace was ridiculously low in front. Eric Raffin glided toward the lead after a kilometer with Jazzy Perrine, but soon thereafter the duo had to let outside horse Joke to the lead. And the pace continued to be very low, so when the field turned into the last turn and Jazzy Perrine still was looking for racing room in the pocket, it seemed hopeless for the favorite.

A magician's act by Raffin over the stretch resulted in Jazzy Perrine attacking on the inside of leader Joke and shortly ahead of the wire the favorite was first.

### SBOA eliminations in the books at Woodbine Mohawk Park

Stakes season officially kicked off Friday evening (May 13) at Woodbine Mohawk Park with the SBOA Stakes eliminations for Ontario -sired 3-year-old colts and geldings.

A pair of \$25,000 eliminations were need for both the pacing and trotting divisions. The top-five finishers from each division advanced to next week's finals.

Ontario Sires Stakes Super Final champion **Twin B Archie** converted off a perfect second-over trip from driver James MacDonald to edge Esplosione by a narrow margin in 1:55.3 (**Replay here**).

Star Power Hanover made a second-quarter move to the top to lead the field by the half in :58.3 and three-quarters in 1:28.3. Twin B Archie sat fifth in the early stages and latched on to cover behind Esplosione.

The sophomore trotters sprinted home, with Twin B Archie muscling by a game Esplosione to win by half a length. Mr Fritter grabbed third, while Star Power Hanover settled for fourth.

A gelded son of Archangel, Twin B Archie came in off a pair of qualifiers, winning his most recent in 1:55.3 after making a late break the week prior. The Scott McEneny trainee is now five for 11 lifetime, with nine top three-finishes, and has earned \$297,516 for owners McEneny, Domenic Chiaravalle, Floyd Marshall and Martwest Racing Stable.

Twin B Archie paid \$3 to win.

**Evil Guy** lit up the tote board with a 48-1 stunner in the second elimination.

Evil Guy and driver Trevor Henry stepped out to the early lead, posting a :27.4 opener. Stable Genius looped around to command entering the backstretch and raced by the half in :57.3. Red Overbach came to the outside from third, providing second-over cover for 4/5 favourite Duly Resolved on the far turn.

After reaching three-quarters in 1:26.4, Stable Genuis brought the field into the lane with rivals ready to attack. Duly Resolved tipped off cover to charge down the centre of the track, while

Evil Guy had daylight to exit the two-hole and join the stretch battle. Those two trotters would square off, with Evil Guy prevailing by half a length in 1:54.4 (**Replay here**).

Stable Genius crossed third, while Sea Can was fourth.

A homebred for Bill Mane and William Cripps, Evil Guy was winless in 10 starts coming into his SBOA elimination, including two starts this season. The gelded son of Il Sogno Dream is

trained by Shannon Henry and was competing last season in the OSS Grassroots.

A \$2 win ticket on Evil Guy returned \$99.30.

OSS Super Final winner **Bob Loblaw** turned in an impressive 1:50.3 effort to win the first elimination for colts and geldings (**Replay here**).

Macho Phil outsprinted Contact Zone to grab early command, posting a quick opening-quarter of :26.2. Bob Loblaw got away third and made a second-quarter rush to the top for driver Sylvain Filion and led by panels of :55.4 and 1:24.1.

Ron came first up at the leader on the far turn, but may have only reached the saddle pad before Bob Loblaw kicked home strongly in :26.2 to win by nearly two lengths in a career-best time.

Macho Phil finished second, while Chucky Hanover rallied to finish third. Ron's first-up bid ended in a fourth-place effort.

Trained by Ken Middleton, Bob Loblaw nabbed his first win of the season in his second outing. The gelded son of Sunshine Beach won three of 12 starts in his rookie season, earning over \$233,000 for owners Middleton, Dave Walls, James Grant and Starting Centre Stables.

Bob Loblaw paid \$6.90 to win.

**Stonebridge Helios** made his season debut in style by posting a coast-to-coast 1:51.2 victory in the second elimination (**Replay here**).

Driven by Bob McClure, 'Helios' shot out to the lead and never looked back. The John Pentland trainee posted fractions of :27.3, :56.1 and 1:25.0 before sprinting home in :26.2 for the score.

While a trio of rivals did their best to push the winner, runner-up Cold Creek Queso had a strong final-quarter overturned by

disqualification due to causing interference coming off the final turn. The DQ sent the runner-up back to ninth.

Sport Secret was third placed second, Magical Arthur fourth placed third and Dont Poke The Bear fifth placed fourth.

A son of Sunshine Beach, Stonebridge Helios came into his season debut off a blistering 1:51.1 qualifying victory. The Pentland trainee won four of seven starts last season, never missing the top-three, and earned \$295,710.

Stonebridge Helios is owned by John Fleischman, Angie Stiller and Pentland. He paid \$2.30 to win.

Post-positions for both of next week's finals were scheduled to be drawn immediately following the eliminations, however, the connections of Cold Creek Queso have appealed their disqualification causing the pacing colts and geldings draw to be delayed.

## Takter students sizzle in sire stakes action at the Big M

The Nancy Takter stable is clearly thinking Hambletonian.

Friday night (May 13) at The Meadowlands, Takter sent out a pair of winners during the second leg of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for 3-year-old trotting colts and geldings, and both hit the wire in 1:51.4, the fastest time of the year in the division.

First up was **Pretender**, who went off stride as the 1-5 favorite in the Dexter Cup last Saturday. The Muscle Hill—Maven product surged to the lead at the half in :56.3 after going around early leader El Toro Loco. From there, driver Yannick Gingras was left with little to do as the winner lowered his previous lifetime best by two-and-one-fifth seconds. Testing Testing was second, 3¾ lengths back, with 8-5 favorite B A Superhero, who was looking for his third win in as many 2022 starts, grabbing the show dough.

Pretender returned \$8.00 as the 3-1 third choice in the wagering while upping his lifetime stats to four wins from 15 starts.

"He was just a little bit wide in the Dexter," said Takter. "He needed one more step to get around a horse to his inside or he wouldn't have gone off stride. Tonight, he was super. He gets a little bit anxious, so I left an ear hood on him to make sure he stayed quiet. If he continues to develop, we are trending toward the direction of The Hambletonian."

In the very next race, Takter's **Looks Like Moni**, off a second-place finish to B A Superhero, flashed his big turn of early speed for a second straight week, and this time around finished the job wire to wire, winning by 1 length over Senna. Majestic J was third.

The gelded son of Muscle Hill—That's All Moni blasted to the top from post six and hit the quarter in :27.2, and after backing the second fraction down to :29, trotted his back half in :55.2 to match his stablemate's national-season's mark with Gingras calling the shots.

As the 4-5 public choice, the Hambletonian hopeful paid \$3.60 to win, scoring for the second time from 11 lifetime starts while lowering his previous mark by three-and-two-fifth seconds.

"He was a little bit of his own worst enemy as a 2-year-old," said Takter. "So we gelded him and it's made a world of difference.

He was constantly kicking the walls in his stall. Gelding him has made him tougher. Now, he fights. He was better this week than last. He's still not perfect. I think they are both good horses. It wasn't out of the realm that they would do that [establish the national-season's best], but both are not as perfect as they could be at this point."

**Temporal Hanover** took the other division for males, scoring in a lifetime-best 1:52.3 for driver Brian Sears. For a second straight NJSS start, the son of Walner—Think Twice was explosive through the stretch, rallying off a second-over trip from fifth at three-quarters for trainer Marcus Melander to up his career stats to seven wins from just 14 starts. Brave By Design was 2 lengths back in second with Villain third.

Temporal Hanover paid \$3.40 as the 3-5 favorite.

The Ake Svanstedt trained and driven **Jiggy Jog S** went parked for the final three-eighths before wearing down leader Jaya Bae in the first of two splits for sophomore filly trotters.

The daughter of Walner—Hot Mess Hanover, who missed a nose to Venerable in her seasonal debut, recorded a head victory in a lifetime-best equaling 1:52.2 and paid \$5.00 as the 3-2 second choice in the betting. Misswalner Fashion, the 6-5 favorite who took the 2021 Kindergarten Final, was third making her first start of 2022.

Fashion Schooner scored in the other division for fillies, hitting the wire 3¾ lengths clear of Peyton Hanover in a lifetime-best 1:52, the fastest mile of the season in her division. Primadonna Deo and Disclosure finished in a dead heat for third, but Disclosure was disqualified and placed fifth for going off stride at the finish.

A daughter of Walner—Broadway Schooner, Fashion Schooner took control while parked to the half in :56.2 before rolling home to a dominant score, her second in three starts this year after failing to record a victory in three outings a year ago.

Driven by Tim Tetrick, the Jim Campbell trainee returned \$2.60 to win as the 1-5 public choice.

**NJSS NON-BETTORS**: Before the regular 13-race program, there were a pair of \$20,000 second leg New Jersey Sire Stakes events for 3-year-olds on the pace conducted as non-betting affairs.

In the split for colts and geldings, **Count Mara** went wire-to-wire for Tetrick and trainer John Pyott in 1:59.2. The gelded son of Lis Mara-Madam Countess hit the wire 1¾ lengths in front of second-place finisher Polaris Breech.

**Bee Aware** won her second straight NJSS dash in the division for fillies. The daughter of Great Vintage—M AJackie came from off the pace to register a lifetime-best 1:54.3 score for Steve Smith and Laurie Molnar. Dry Ridge Cutie was three-quarters-of-a-length back in second.



#### To be or not to be

The end of harness racing at Pompano was a bummer. I never visited, never raced a horse there, but wagering on the iPad gave me a good vibe. The absence of racing in Florida gives us all bad vibes. Rising Phoenix-like from sporting extinction is not easy. Here is a shortlist of sports that did not make it back to popularity:

- <u>Auto Polo</u> Like horse polo, except the players were on automobiles instead of horses.
- <u>Barrel Jumping</u> Where ice skaters attempted to jump over a series of barrels.
- Board Track Racing A motorsport popular in the United States between the 1910s and 1920s. Competitions took place on circular or oval racecourses composed of wooden planks.
- <u>Coaching</u> Elaborate replications of early mail routes using large stagecoaches with teams of four horses.
- <u>Chariot Racing</u> The most popular sport in Ancient Greece, Rome, and the Byzantine Era.
- <u>Club Swinging</u> A sport involving the competitor standing with a bowling pin-shaped club in each hand and then whirling or swinging the clubs very quickly around the body and head in various patterns in a complicated routine.
- Fox Tossing A person on each end of a sling tosses the fox upwards; the team with the highest throw wins.
- Goose Pulling In this sport, a goose was hung by its legs while a man on horseback attempted to grab it by the neck to try and pull its head off.
- Jeu de Paume Originally played with the hand, the precursor to tennis and modern lawn tennis.
- Jousting A medieval sport in which two horseback competitors, wielding long lances with blunted tips, tried to take each other down.
- Knurr and spell An old English game from Yorkshire, England, used a stick to hit a ball launched from a trap.

- Kolven A medieval sport from the Netherlands where the aim was to hit a ball to a target in the minimum number of strokes, a precursor to golf.
- La Soule A traditional team sport that originated in Normandy and Picardy. Teams from neighboring parishes played with the aim of the game to bring a ball back to the team's parish church, with or without sticks. The sport was also known as choule.
- Pall Mall A lawn game that was a precursor to croquet played between the 1500's and 1600's.
- Pedestrianism A 19th-century form of competitive walking.
- Quintain Horseback competitors with long lances tried to hit a stationary object hanging from a pole.

Perhaps future people will chuckle when they read the updated list of extinct sports and see <u>Harness horse racing</u> - Horses using a specific gait to haul human beings seated in bicycle-like carts for one mile in circles at breathtaking speeds.

Most of us involved in our sport would prefer to follow in the footsteps of Kolven or Jeu de Paume. We want to keep our sport around in some form.

No doubt there were wagers on the above sports. We could all imagine ourselves wagering on who would pull the head off the dangling goose or how close to noon the stagecoach would arrive at the Dover Pub. A few pence or drachma on the outcome

of an event always spices up the game, but most games do not rely on this income. Gambling money was always floating around, but, in our case, gambling was everything.

If the Pall Mall league wanted to avoid extinction, they needed to find people and places for the games and ways to subsidize the expenses. If you're involved in competitive Pall Mall, yachting racing, or polo matches, the participants will pay the bulk of the bills, which will be high. Finding enough people with enthusiasm and money who desire to play on will be the dividing line. Heck, auto polo would still be popular if enough players were enthusiastic, rich, and determined enough.

If harness racing sport sputters towards an end, as it did in Florida, the odds are that some will still wish to continue racing beautiful horses in harness.

Hopefully, the sport will return to where it began, with a group of deep-pocketed people who have a thirst for the game and can afford to quench that thirst.

We all understood that harness racing in Florida was in jeopardy. We are all glum that it occurred. Peons are not much help. However, if wealthy harness racing enthusiasts in Florida spent those days counting down to the last race at Pompano designing a viable stakes racing program for the state, or a replacement racetrack, we would be looking ahead and not looking back.

If innovative benefactors said, "The hell with politicians and gambling revenue, let's revive harness horseracing in Florida. We can do something to make racing fun and somewhat feasible for people to play. We will make lemonade out of the lemons.

Maybe the sport may not rely totally on a pari-mutuel racetrack for a while, but it WILL be."

Who knows what is possible? Who knows what bright minds can create?

Savvy sporting businesspeople who have resources could take this looming void in Florida as a challenge. What an exciting project for a handful of people with disposable assets and a love for a free-legged trotter in full flight. Resurrecting harness racing in Florida would be an exciting, fulfilling task. Indeed, it would be an improvement from sulking around muttering, "What happened to Pompano stinks."

The brave, creative warriors could have started preparing for the transition years ago or six months ago, but hopefully, someone will start today. Doing the impossible is possible for extraordinary people.

Are you one of those people?

Do you dream big?

Could you take our game into the next phase and provide a framework for racing?

Could we be better than ever?

Or are we destined to be Fox Tossers in Florida?

## Barn Hall ties trotting mark at Buffalo Raceway

After blowing out the field by five lengths last week in the \$15,000 open trot at Buffalo Raceway, what could **Barn Hall** do for an encore on Friday afternoon (May 13)?

Well, he beat the open field once again, but equaled the all-aged colt and horse trotting track record of 1:56.2 set by Purpose Blue Chip back on June 7, 2018 in posting the victory.

On a perfect spring afternoon with a post time temperature of 80 degrees and a lightning fast track, it was ideal conditions for Barn Hall (\$3.50) to strut his stuff.

Starting from the four hole, Barn Hall (Kevin Cummings) had to work hard in going three-wide early as Mystical Sarabi and Schnickel Fritz played hard ball. Finally clearing just past the opening quarter which went in :28.4, Barn Hall knew he was now the target of the first over Lougazi (Ray Fisher Jr.).

With splits of :58 and 1:27,1, Barn Hall prepared for the impending battle with Lougazi in the stretch. But Barn Hall had more than enough artillery to turn away Lougazi by three quarters length in tying the all-time colt and horse trotting record of 1:56.2. Mystical Sarabi (Dan Yetman), the lone mare in the event, was a very game third, finishing just 1-1/2 lengths behind the winner.

Co-owned by trainer Steven Pratt, Nancy Pratt, the Purple Haze Stables and Out In The Country Stable, it was the second win in four tries this season for 4-year-old horse Barn Hall (Conway Hall—Exotic Form). The victory jumped his seasonal earnings to \$18,750 and \$143,546 in his career.
