# Confederation Cup, SBOA finals and OSS part of jam-packed weekend in Ontario

Stakes season is in full force as Canada celebrates Victoria Day holiday weekend.

Ontario harness racing fans got their first taste of stakes action last weekend with eliminations for the Standardbred Breeders of Ontario Association (SBOA) Stakes and the Confederation Cup and the fun continues this weekend with the finals for both events.

The Ontario Sired fillies will kick things off on Saturday night at Woodbine Mohawk Park in the SBOA finals and Hall

of Fame trainer Bob McIntosh has not one, but two shots at the \$165,290 pacing filly prize with **Sunny Dee** (Post 2) and **Thats Incredible** (Post 3).

Both fillies won their eliminations last weekend, with favourite Sunny Dee controlling the tempo on her way to a 1:52.3 score and Thats Incredible overcoming a brief interference break to post a 1:53 victory. **Girls Got Rhythm** sprinted home to a 1:52.3 victory in the other elimination and will start from Post 4.

The elimination win was Sunny Dee's sixth straight, a statistic that does not surprise McIntosh, who has been impressed by the Sunshine Beach daughter since her earliest lessons.

"I was really high on her last year as a 2-year-old. She was training down beautifully, but she had a habit of kicking the stall walls and damned if she didn't fracture a coffin bone in her left hind. We sent her down to Rood and Riddle to Dr. Larry Bramlage and he said she'll be fine next year, but that

cost us the year unfortunately," McIntosh said, adding that the filly currently resides in a well-padded stall. "I was high on her last year and she came back and was even better this year and she's just never really given me any ulcerous days.

"Of course, she's out of that great mare West Of L A too, super mare, hopefully someday she'll be a Hall of Fame broodmare because she's got two millionaires already, looks like she's on her way to her third maybe." Sunny Dee's half-siblings are Somewhere In L A and L A Delight. "But other than that, you feel like you're going a quarter in 30 seconds or 34 seconds and she's going in :28, her length of her stride is just incredible. There's nothing I can say bad about her."

Trevor Henry drove both Sunny Dee and Thats Incredible to their elimination victories and opted for Sunny Dee in the final. Paul MacDonell, who piloted Thats Incredible in her first two sophomore starts, will return to the Bettors Delight daughter's race bike.

In the \$164,290 SBOA Trotting Filly final, elimination winners **Haveoneforme** and **Bright Eyes M** will start from Posts 2 and 3, respectively. The trotting filly final goes postward as Race 6 on the 6:45 pm card, with the pacing fillies squaring off in Race 8.

While McIntosh does not have a starter in the Confederation Cup final at Flamboro Downs on Sunday, he



will be heading to the Dundas, ON oval with four Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) competitors for the provincial program's season opener. Three-year-old trotting geldings **Judge Ken** (Post 2, Race 1) and **A Royal Line** (Post 5, Race 4) will compete in Gold Series action while sophomore pacing geldings **Lucky Levis** (Post 4, Race 7) and **Head To The Beach** (Post 1, Race 8) will battle in the Grassroots opener. Trevor Henry will be in the race bike behind all four youngsters.

"All of these horses that are going to Flamboro are good on a half, or else I wouldn't have put them in, that was a factor," said McIntosh.

The OSS colts will serve as the opening act for the \$188,500 Confederation Cup Final, with the trotting colts squaring off in Races 1, 4 and 6 and the pacing colts going postward in Races 3, 5, 7, 8, and 9, warming fans up for the Cup final in Race 10.

After capturing their eliminations, Ron Burke trainees **Dorsoduro Hanover** and **Done Well** will be battling for the

Confederation Cup title from Posts 1 and 5, respectively. Matt

Kakaley will be back in the race bike behind Dorsoduro

Hanover, who was a 1:53.4 winner over a sloppy Flamboro

oval last Sunday, and Dexter Dunn will be back aboard Done

Well, who impressed Flamboro fans with a 1:51.4 clocking on
the front end.

Last year's OSS Gold and Grassroots champions **Jimmy Freight** and **Pretty Handsome** both advanced to the final and will start side-by-side from Posts 3 and 4.

"Jimmy Freight got us qualified for the Confederation Cup final last Sunday with a nice effort (fourth) from the eight-hole," said driver Louis-Philippe Roy, who steers the pacer for trainer Richard Moreau and owner Adriano Sorella. "I like his chances with the draw; Jimmy never disappointed me."

Pretty Handsome's trainer Andrew McCabe said he and owner Robert Schlegel of Glenview Livestock Ltd. are simply delighted the Mach Three son earned a berth in the final. "We feel quite elated to have made the final," said McCabe,



who will hand the lines to regular reinsman Jonathan Drury on Sunday. "It's definitely exciting to race against some of North America's best 4-year-olds."

If the weather is a bit more cooperative this week, the nine finalists, who also include **American History** (Post 4), **The Downtown Bus** (Post 6), **Rockin Speed** (Post 7), **This Is The Plan** (Post 9) and **Ghost Dance** (Post 9), could be taking aim on the Flamboro Downs track record, set by Somebeachsomewhere in the 2008 Cup final. Post time for Sunday's program is 6:55 pm.

#### **CITY OF LONDON STARTS WEDNESDAY**

Also getting underway next week is the City of London Series at The Raceway at Western Fair District. Eliminations for the pacing divisions are Wednesday, May 22 and the trotting eliminations go postward Friday, May 24. The finals for all four events will be part of the Camluck Classic undercard at the London, ON oval on Friday, May 31.

"The City Of London is an important series for us and a staple of our closing night program at The Raceway," said director of racing Greg Blanchard of the series, which is for Ontario Sired horses that were non-winners of \$10,000 lifetime as of Feb. 28. "These are horses who, for one reason or another, have taken a little bit longer to find their game, but the finals generally always end up being competitive affairs.

"We are happy to have been able to maintain this series as we feel it's important to horsepeople who rely on these types of series to properly bring along younger horses who just needed that extra time to mature."

A few additional horses are taking advantage of the late blooming opportunity this year as nominations for the series were up by 51 over 2018 totals. The most notable increase came in the pacing categories, with 28 additional horses and geldings and 17 more fillies and mares nominated.

#### **DRESDEN OPENING MAY 26**

Dresden Raceway also kicks off its season next week, raising the curtain on its 11-day meet Sunday, May 26. Among the highlights of the half-mile oval's summer schedule is the annual Canada Day program on July 1, featuring an OSS Grassroots event for the 3-year-old trotting fillies and the Mark Austin Pacing Series Final. Post time for each of the Dresden, ON track's Sunday afternoon matinees is 1:30 pm.

# Handsome Brad wins Copenhagen Cup

After a positive runner-up performance, second to Propulsion, in Olympiatravet a few weeks ago, 6-year-old Handsome Brad was ready for a group 1-victory in Scandinavia.

The \$113,000 Copenhagen Cup was held at Charlottenlund racetrack in Denmark last Sunday and Ulf Stenströmer-trained Handsome Brad could easily keep first choice Cyber Lane on the outside when the car left the field in the 1.3 miles long race.

When in front, Handsome Brad, driven by Carl Johan Jepson, controlled the race every meter and via a quick last quarter of a mile, the son of Brad de Veluwe held his opponents in safe distance all the way to the wire.

Stenströmer has a great ability to make trotters develop after the tough years as 3- and 4-year-olds and he has earlier presented top trotters as Noras Bean and Your Highness in the elite class.

Handsome Brad won in a mile rate of 1:54.4 over 1.3 miles and Cyber Lane held strongly to second place, ahead of Generaal Bianco.

The entourage around winner Handsome Brad got the question regarding an entry in Elitloppet, but Stenströmer has communicated that they will aim for other objectives later this summer.

#### Nadal Broline speedy for Goop

At Solvalla on Tuesday night, Nadal Broline made an impressive comeback for his new trainer Björn Goop.

Nine-year-old Nadal Broline (Yankee Glide) had been successful in Reijo Liljendahl's stable, but since mid-February, Goop has been the new trainer. In the \$42,000 Meadow Roads race, Nadal Broline won in season best time on a 5/8 mile track in Europe. From second over, with Perfect Spirit in the lead, Nadal Broline had to leave three wide before the

last turn and the battle in the home stretch was between him and Milliondollarrhyme where Nadal Broline showed great courage when he beat the freshman Milliondollarrhyme just before the wire in 1:51.1. High grades are given to both him and the runner up, who never had tried this kind of opponents earlier in his career.

But the Elitloppet is, probably, out of the question for Nadal Broline, whom Goop said was too old and would be better suited for other targets later on this season.

#### 15 in a row for Aubrion du Gers

Jean-Michel Bazire has accepted his invitation to the Elitlopp with Aubrion du Gers (Memphis du Rib) whom is one of the top four choices to win at Solvalla on Sunday, May 26.

In the \$125,000 Prix de Ducs de Normandie in Caen, France, Bazire sent his 9-year-old gelding to front at an early stage and the duo got Bold Eagle, driven by Björn Goop behind them.

Bazire made sure that he never gave free space for Bold Eagle to use and Aubrion du Gers sprinted to his 15th consecutive win in a mile rate of 1:56.3 over 1.5 miles.

The gelding's next objective is the Elitloppet at Solvalla.

#### Two more invited to Elitlopp

Solvalla invited two new horses to the Elitlopp earlier this week.

Finlandia-ajo runner up Next Direction, owned in Finland, and Swedish-owned Disco Volante are both ready for start at Solvalla next week.

Twelve horses are set for Elitloppet at this point and on Saturday, a ticket is at stake when Gävle racetrack stages the \$103,000 Prins Daniels lopp over a mile. Title defender Ringostarr Treb is the probable first choice, but trainer Jerry Riordan has said that he will not race Ringostarr Treb at Solvalla if he wins in Gävle.

### Peter Haughton Memorial winner dead

Weingartner (Donato Hanover), who won Peter Haughton Memorial for trainer Jimmy Takter (brother Johnny drove at that time) in 2011, died in an accident at Stuteri Shadow in Denmark this week, according to Trav-og Galoppnytt in Norway.

Weingartner has served mares in Sweden during five seasons before he moved to Denmark last year.











# Thoughts on Ohio's microchip fiasco, the role of secretaries, fining drivers for a slow pace and my take on hay cubes

**Tidbits:** I mistakenly named Woodside Charm in my Road to the Hambletonian, not knowing she was not eligible. I apologize for the error. It is sad she is not eligible. Checking out last year's fabulous performances she would be more than competitive.

To all you Raptors fans, consider how kind the last bounce was to you on Sunday night. The one man Leonard Show cannot carry you over the super talented Bucks.

Congratulations to the powers that be in the NBA for introducing a much-improved format to the draft lottery. It is a certainty that reducing the chances for a number one pick down to 14 per cent for the three worst teams will lessen the tanking policies of recent years. It's sort of like the half empty / half full scenario, but no one pointed out that if you have a 14 per cent chance to win you also have an 86 per cent chance to lose. As it turned out, the winner of the Zion lottery was New Orleans, the team that tied for seventh worst. So, the new design works. The Knicks with the best chance in the old format were reduced to the fourth overall pick on the 20th of June when the official draft will be held. Sadly, It seemed that Zion Williamson, the great Duke star, was either perplexed by the result or unhappy as he was not all smiles after the announcement.

One way or the other, he is on his way to a LeBron or Michael bank account. There have been first picks in the draft that refused to play for the team that chose them, but Zion seems much to class a kid to head in that direction. The bottom line is that this may just solve the year-long turmoil in the Big Easy, and get Anthony Davis to reconsider his desires to find happiness in another venue. Word on the street has it that the lottery meant nothing to Davis and he still wants out of New Orleans, but please don't quote me.

Only time will tell.

Fabulous weekend of racing at the Meadowlands starting tonight, with the first round of the NJSS and then tomorrow with the Graduate, the Rainbow Blue and the Mr Muscleman. See the likes of Atlanta, Six Pack, Phaetosive, Kissin in the Sand, Youaremycandygirl, Caviar's Ally and Gold Orchid N perform.

I saw a very good movie on demand last night. If you can watch a film with subtitles I have a good one for you. EVERYBODY KNOWS with Javier Bardem and Penelope Cruz is very entertaining. Takes place in Spain where a wedding is attended by Cruz's large family and ex-lover Bardem (her real life husband both from Barcelona). During the festivities her teenage daughter is kidnapped. Great story.

# Paul Robinson asks: What is your take on the microchip fiasco in Ohio? Was the decision a proper one?

I equate the mess in Ohio with the mess in the Kentucky Derby. Although I maintain that both decisions were beyond wrong, I have little problem understanding how the results were achieved. "By the Book" is commonplace among robotic employees. It's easier than the alternative. When you have to think to come up with the answer it is quicker and less provocative to do what the rule says. You can get fired for thinking but they can't or won't can you for abiding by the rules.

In both these cases, the powers that be went "By the Book". It's safe and easy. However, that doesn't mean it was right. In retrospect, I think some steps could be taken to right the wrongs. I think it would be nice for the Ohio Commission and or Miami Valley to refund the Kings and their owners all the money paid into the race as well as all the expenses as a gesture of good will for the mistake in judgement that transpired.

I can't go there in Kentucky because that is worse than a lost cause. The commission has given Luis Saez (the jockey on the disqualified horse) a 15-day suspension. Not because he deserve it, or any days for that matter, but to cover their butts after an egregious error in judgment precipitated by going "By the Book".

I have read a multitude of opinions on the race and unlike the Ohio situation where 95 per cent of the opinions are the Commission was wrong, the Kentucky affair remains at 50/50. There's little chance when these decisions go to court that they will be overturned, and although in this writer's opinion it is nowhere near 50/50, deep down inside I feel that there is a small chance of a reversal. Maybe just wishful thinking but I have seen it happen.

I will say one thing in closing. If the judges in Kentucky

had put up a stewards inquiry immediately after the race I would feel a lot better, but the foul claim by a totally uninvolved jockey (who just happened to have finished second) precipitating the DQ makes me crazy.

Thomas Brown asks: Is the racing secretary solely responsible for setting race conditions at each track? Is there any oversight from the USTA? Sometimes the conditions are so broad it allows the better class of horses to fall into a race they shouldn't be allowed in. Another question, years ago the judges fined drivers for slowing down the pace. Why don't they still do that?

The answer to you first question is yes. The racing secretary sets the racing conditions for each track. The USTA has nothing at all to do with it. The secretary or director of racing has the knowledge of the horses he has available to race and the amount in the purse account that may be used on a program to program basis.

The lack of horses available at most tracks of late is the main reason that some of the conditions seem so wide open. The racing office wants to provide the customers with the best available product as well as the fullest possible fields. Five or six horses in a race is not attractive to any gambler. It is also the job of the racing secretary to place the fields that you call too broad that have an odds-on favorites, or very short fields, in a place where they don't affect the handle as much, for example the second half of the early or late daily double.

As far as drivers being fined for slowing the pace, it certainly still exists but with the speed we are racing and the higher purse structure it is not as prevalent as it was in years past. When I was a kid it would take a 33 or 34-second quarter for a judge to evoke a penalty. Today, if I were in the booth I could see a fine for going 30 seconds, especially after a 27-second previous panel as the slow down would cause confusion behind the lead horse.



Toni David asks: We feed the best hay we can get but I know a lot of barns feed hay cubes. What hay do you like the best to feed racehorses and how do you feel about cubes?

I trained horses for 60 years in the first half rarely if ever did we know that a horse "tied up" (severe muscle cramps i.e a swimmer or basketball player). The second half it seemed to happen way too often. I think that from the beginning I learned that alfalfa hay or a rich Timothy and Alfalfa mix was best for the racehorse. Whether it is breeding or an increased amount of certain elements in the feeding program, today's horse does NOT flourish on rich hay. At the end I found that straight Timothy was best.

To be honest, I hated feeding any hay at all. Most of the time I would buy a few bales to appease my caretakers because they loved giving it to their horses in the morning when they are waiting to be jogged. I do on the other hand love hay cubes.

For certain, there is no waste, especially if you bed on straw where half the hay gets mixed in and is discarded every morning. Any trainer that is the slightest bit cost conscious should be aware that cubes are the way to go. Most of the good cubes are from Canada and a nice mix of hay that is not to rich, although you can but straight alfalfa cubes.

While on the subject I would also suggest that high protein, low fat feed should not be your preference. Your horses will be more relaxed and keep their weight with lower protein and higher fat content feed. There is nothing wrong with oats and sweet feed. I don't think pellets are a must, although I do prefer them mainly because your horse will have a more nutritious and more balanced diet.

I prefer not to name products in my column but if you are interested in what brands are best for you ask any top trainer they will be glad to help you.

# Fast trotters gather for Saturday's opening round of Graduate Series

Jim Campbell figures when you bring together many of the best 4-year-old trotters in North America, there is no such thing as an easy spot.

So, although his returning millionaire Crystal Fashion will avoid two 2018 Dan Patch Award winners (Atlanta and Six Pack) and a 2017 Breeders Crown champion (Fiftydallarbill) in Saturday's (May 18) opening round of the Graduate Series at The Meadowlands, Campbell is not expecting a stroll in the park. Crystal Fashion competes in the second of two \$50,000 divisions, starting from post one with regular driver Tim Tetrick.

"On paper maybe the other one does look a little tougher, but when you go race them, they're all going to go fast and they're all going to be tough," Campbell said. "So, I don't put a lot of thought into that. Every time I think there is a division that looks easier on paper, they always go more.

"It's a good group of 4-year-olds out there. The only thing I worry about is my own horse. We're going to send him out

there to race and whatever happens, it happens. Just being at the Meadowlands, you know they're going to be going fast no matter what."

Generating speed is not an issue for this group. Returning Trotter of the Year Atlanta, with her 1:50.4 season-opening win in the Miami Valley Distaff on May 6, is the year's fastest trotter, while Fiftydallarbill's 1:51.3 time in winning a conditioned race last weekend at the Meadowlands is second best.

And last year, Six Pack became the sport's fastest-ever 3-year-old with a 1:49.1 win in the Kentucky Futurity in addition to trotting 1:50 earlier in the campaign while Crystal Fashion tied for the sixth-fastest mile ever by a 3-year-old (1:50.1).

Not to be forgotten, Atlanta won the Hambletonian in 1:50.4 and had a season-best mark of 1:50.3, which ranks seventh among all female 3-year-old trotters in history, and multiple stakeswinner Phaetosive — who is in Saturday's second Graduate division with Crystal Fashion — was not far off with a 1:51 mark.

Crystal Fashion, who won nine of 17 races last year including the Canadian Trotting Classic and Earl Beal Jr.

Memorial, made his first start of 2019 on May 4 in the Great Northeast Open Series for trotters at Harrah's Philadelphia, where he finished fourth.

"He's the type of horse that needs to get racing to get himself tight," Campbell said. "He's going to need some more racing to get himself into top shape, but I was very happy with his first race.

"He hasn't really changed (from last year). He's got the same personality and everything like that. He maybe filled out a little more, but for both a 2-year-old and a 3-year-old he was a good-sized colt. Maybe he grew a little bit, but for the most part he's pretty much the same."

Phaetosive, who won last year's Elegantimage Stakes, will be making her seasonal debut, as is New York Sire Stakes final runner-up The Veteran. Custom Cantab, an Indiana Sire Stakes champion mare who won 13 of 17 races last season including the Matron, heads to the Graduate's second division off a third-place finish in the Miami Valley Distaff.

In the first division, Six Pack and Eurobond are the two trotters making their seasonal debuts. Six Pack won 11 of 15 races last year including the Kentucky Futurity, Yonkers Trot, and Matron. He received the Dan Patch Award for best 3-year-old male trotter.

"He trained back good," trainer/-driver Ake Svanstedt said of Six Pack. "He qualified two times. He was maybe a little lazy the last qualifier, but he had an open bridle. I think he is sharp now. He feels much better when we train after the second qualifier. I hope he can do a good race.

"We're going to race him in the Graduate and then the Hambletonian Maturity. After that he can go in the open. He feels strong. He's a big horse. He is so big I think he can be stronger when he is older. We'll see after a couple of races what he can do."

In addition to Atlanta, there will be a second Hambletonian winner competing on Saturday's card at the Meadowlands as 2015 champion Pinkman looks to pick up his second win in the Mr Muscleman Series for older trotters. A total of four Hambletonian winners will be in action this year: Atlanta, Pinkman, Perfect Spirit (in Europe) and Marion Marauder.

The Meadowlands also plays host to the second round of the Rainbow Blue Series for older female pacers on Saturday. The six-horse field includes Dan Patch Award winners Kissin In The Sand (2018) and Youaremycandygirl (2017) as well as millionaire Caviart Ally.

Racing begins at 7:15 p.m. (EDT).

Fans got their first look at Swedish-bred trotter Darling Mearas during Saturday's (May 11) qualifiers at the Meadowlands Racetrack, but they will have to wait a little longer than anticipated to see the 6-year-old mare in her first race in North America.

Darling Mearas, who earned \$750,199 in Europe and counted the 2016 Swedish Trotting Oaks and 2018 European Championship for mares among her wins, posted a 1:56.1 victory in her Big M qualifier for trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt. But Svanstedt was not completely happy with the performance, so he plans to delay Darling Mearas' debut, which was expected to come in Monday's (May 20) first round of the Miss Versatility Series at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"She trained back good but when she qualified, I was not a hundred per cent satisfied with her," said Svanstedt, who took over the training of Darling Mearas following her arrival in the U.S. earlier this spring. "We're not going to race her yet. We're going to wait a couple of weeks. Her gait was not perfect in the last turn. She must feel a little bit better."

Darling Mearas, a daughter of Cantab Hall out of the Muscles Yankee mare Khao Manee, won 12 of 29 races in Europe for trainer Stefan Persson and breeder/owner Snogarps Gård, a farm run by the Wihlborg family. The family might be best known to North American racing fans as the owner of 2014 Breeders Crown champion Commander Crowe, who earned \$5.09 million worldwide in his career.

Calle Wihlborg told Sweden's Sulky Sport magazine the decision to send Darling Mearas to North America was made in part because she would have more opportunities to race in stakes events restricted to mares. Svanstedt was selected as the trainer because "purely historically, he has been very good at getting older horses to take another step."

Darling Mearas is staked to a number of Grand Circuit events this season, including the Breeders Crown, Armbro Flight, Dr. John R. Steele Memorial, and the TVG Championship.

"The plan is to race her here this summer and then breed her with a top stallion here in America next spring," Svanstedt said. "She is a good horse. She was one of the best mares and she was a good horse in the stakes races when she was young. She has a lot of power and she wants to do the job. She is always nice to drive and if you ask her, she does the job."

# 'Emperor' looks to reign

When trainer John McDermott approached the owners of star-crossed male pacer Hurrikane Kingcole and mare Hurrikane Schmumma to float the idea of breeding them, Jonathan Klee was unsure what to think.

"I remember telling John, I'm not a breeder, I'm a lawyer," said Klee, who was among the owners of both horses. "However, we all believed in Kingcole and John can be convincing, so all the owners discussed it and we gave it a go."

It turned out to be a wise choice.

The first mating of Hurrikane Kingcole to Hurrikane Schmumma in 2014 resulted in a filly, Hurrikane Empress, who won a New Jersey Sire Stakes championship and finished her career with \$219,902 in purses. She is now in foal to Sweet Lou.

The second mating resulted in a colt, Hurrikane Emperor, who last year at age 2 captured sire stakes titles in New Jersey and Kentucky and was named New Jersey's Standardbred of the Year. He won seven of nine races and earned \$226,900 under the tutelage of McDermott and his son John Jr.

"Last year was a dream come true," Klee said. "Unlike buying a horse at a sale or claiming a horse, when you own the sire, dam and foal it's a different type of feeling. Emperor is like a child to all of us. We have known everything about him since birth."

Hurrikane Emperor begins his 2019 season tonight (May 17) in the first round of the New Jersey Sire Stakes at The Meadowlands. His connections are hoping for not only success in state-bred stakes action this year but on the Grand Circuit as well.

"If everything goes perfectly, we'll go through the New Jersey Sire Stakes and use it as kind of a stepping-stone to the North America Cup," said Jeff Kuhen, another of Hurrikane Emperor's breeders/owners. "It's been pretty great to see that Emperor is as good as Kingcole was, if not hopefully better.

"He hasn't done anything yet, knock on wood, to show us that he can't go on any track and race any kind of style. That's why I'm pretty excited to see what he can do this year."

Driven primarily by Dan Dube, the colt won from off the pace and from the front last year and impressed with his ability to relax at any point during a race. His fastest win time, 1:49.3 in his half-length triumph over Blood Money in the Kentucky Sire Stakes final at Red Mile, was tied for the

fifth best of the season by a 2-year-old pacer.

"He impresses me more every day I'm with him," said McDermott, who also trained Hurrikane Kingcole and Hurrikane Schmumma. "His potential is endless. He's got wicked speed like his father, but he's the most intelligent and manageable horse I've ever been around. He's so cool about things.

"He didn't get that from dad," the trainer added with a laugh. "The thing people don't know about his father was that his father was relaxed. The problem was that once you started him, you couldn't stop him. Emperor can leave, sit, come back, do anything you want. That's the beautiful thing about him."

Hurrikane Kingcole, speedy but rarely healthy, won 14 of 49 career races and equaled a world record in 2012 with a 1:48.1 mile at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono. His career mark of 1:47.3 came in the consolation division of the Meadowlands Pace. He now performs stud duty in Australia.

In addition to Klee and Kuhen, Hurrikane Emperor is owned by the third of the three breeders, Pegasis Investment Group, as well as William Garofalo. The colt is eligible to most of the major open stakes for 3-year-old male pacers including the North America Cup, Max C. Hempt Memorial, Meadowlands Pace, Adios, and Cane Pace. He is not eligible to the Breeders Crown.

"We will give him every chance to prove how good he can be," Klee said. "It will be a tribute to all of the little owners, breeders and farms who dream of breeding and racing a champion if Emperor can go out, compete, and win at the highest level."

On Monday (May 13), the New York Sire Stakes (NYSS) made their first stop of the year at Monticello Raceway for 3-year-old pacing colts, the conditions were less than ideal as it was a cold, rainy, raw day that was reminiscent of a fall day and certainly not the middle of May.

Hickfromfrenchlick, the Ray Schnittker-trained son of So Surreal started from post position 4 and went off the 1-5 odds on favorite in the six-horse field. Hickfromfrenchlick (Mark Macdonald) led the pack every step of the way, reeling off even-rated fractions of :28.2, :58.1 and 1:28.1. American Mercury (Tim Tetrick) was the first to move down the backside as the outer flow developed with Stone Hanover right behind him. It looked like Hickfromfrenchlick was going in for an easy layup, but American Mercury was not done yet as the duo paced home strong, but Hickfromfrenchlick rebuffed American Mercury by a scant neck to score in 1:55, pacing his last ¼ in :27 in the fastest mile of the afternoon.

Stone Hanover finished third, coming home in :26.4. Hickfromfrenchlick is owned by Ray Schnittker, Nolamaura Racing LLC and TC Spatorico.

In the second NYSS division was a race of the Majors. Major Blake left fast from post 4 from the gate but decided to take the 2- hole tuck as **Major March** from the rail cut the steady fractions of :28.2,:58.1 and 1:26.4. Respect The Flag and Astaire angled out past the ¾ maker in an effort to start tracking down Major Blake, but their efforts were thwarted as he coasted to a 2 length victory in 1:55. Major March is trained by soon-to-be Hall of Famer Linda Toscano, the Art Major –Mach You And Me colt is owned by Bay Pond Racing Stable of Malvern, PA. Major Blake was second and Astaire finished third.

The highly-touted Reigning Deo highlighted the last heat of Sire Stakes in the 6th race. The Rock N Roll Heaven colt started from the rail and was the 3-5 favorite going to post. Dealer's Table (PP4) and Jason Bartlett cut the soft fractions to the ¾ pole of :29.3, :59.3 and 1:28.1. **Rollwithpapajoe** (Tyler Buter) was the first to come off the rail approaching the half, he continued the overland route with no cover. Heading for home he rolled to an easy three-length win over Reigning Deo, followed by Covered Bridge. Rollwithpapajoe is trained Jenn Bongiorno. The Roll With Joe colt is owned by Barbara Bongiorno, BK Lambos and D. Libertos.

The NYUSS Excelsior A contests saw **Shim** (American ideal – Feel Life) leave the gate unhurried to rally over Caviart Cale in 1:58.3 for trainer/driver and part owner Pat Lachance. In the second A class, **Surreal Art** (So Surreal–Artcotic) was content to sit the pocket while Shanghai Bobby cut the mile. It was a good battle down the lane between the two but Surreal Art hung on for a neck victory over Shanghai Phil in 1:55.1

Sire stats for the afternoon showed American Ideal and So Surreal both had two winners, Jason Bartlett and Patrick LaChance each had a driving double on the chilly afternoon. \$461,000 was wagered on the 8- race card for a per race average of \$57,625.

# Great Northeast wins to Tequila Monday, Guardian Angel As

**Tequila Monday** was an in-charge repeat winner in the Great Northeast Open Series (GNOS) for mare pacers Sunday night (May 12) at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, home in 1:52.1 over a "sloppy +1" track with the mercury hovering around 40. In the companion GNOS contest for open trotters,

also worth \$30,000, **Guardian Angel AS** was sharp in his second outing of the year, winning easily in 1:53.1, with Homicide Hunter never a major factor in his debut for both the year and for the Burke Brigade.

Kissin In The Sand, second after going first-over against Tequila Monday in the GNOS opener last Saturday, was scratched sick here, taking a little of the drama out of the race, but the great 2018 filly champion, even with expected improvement in her second seasonal start, would have had it tough against the razor-sharp winning daughter of American Ideal—Margarita Monday. The rest of her opposition sure did.

Apple Bottom Jeans got her customary flying start even from the outside post seven, with Tequila Monday and Bettor Joy N looped and pressing onward on the first turn. Tequila Monday made the lead nearing the :27 quarter; Bettor Joy N, enjoying her cover until then, went on to get the lead at the three-eighths, backing off the half to :56.1 and the three-quarters in 1:25.

However, Bettor Joy N hadn't raced since the Blue Chip Final on April 20 after her Ohio difficulty, and in the :27.1 sprint home Tequila Monday roared up the famed Pocono Pike, going by easily for a 1¼ length victory. Bettor Joy N held admirably for second, with Apple Bottom Jeans clearing late and coming on for third.

Tequila Monday has now won all six of her seasonal races, with earnings of \$91,750 this year and \$833,462 lifetime, during which she has won 23 of 50 starts. Tyler Buter, who is winning quite more than his share of feature races at Pocono in recent days, had the sulky assignment for trainer Hunter Oakes and the ownership of Northfolk Racing Stable and Chuck Pompey.

In the GNOS trotting event, Guardian Angel AS, fourth from the trailing post eleven in his seasonal bow at The Meadowlands after coming from ninth at the ¾, obviously benefited from the outing (the bettors made him the favorite). He let JL Cruze speed away to take the early lead then moved outside to the :27.3 quarter and took command, hanging up middle fractions of :56.4 and 1:25.1, with La Grange A gaining first-over.

The victorious son of Archangel—Provide As, though, had plenty left in the tank, sprinting home in :28 to be 3¾ lengths clear for driver Tim Tetrick, with La Grange A and Weslynn Dancer next in line. Homicide Hunter, unraced since winning the Breeders Crown here last Oct. 27, had a wave of trotters leave inside of him from the outside post eight, settled in fourth, and then stayed in rather than go out for a second move after the long layoff. He was shuffled behind a tired horse in the last quarter, finishing sixth.

Guardian Angel AS, meanwhile raised his lifetime bankroll to \$544,780 with his 17th win in 42 lifetime trips to the gate. A winner in a Breeders Crown elim here last year (he was fourth in the final), the winner is trained by Anette Lorentzon for ACL Stuteri AB and Kjell Johansson.

# Captain Crunch makes 2019 debut in PASS Sunday at Pocono

Captain Crunch, the 2018 sophomore pacing colt of the year, makes his 2019 debut in the middle of three divisions of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes second preliminary for the glamour division, to be held at Mohegan Sun Pocono on Sunday night (May 19) in races nine through 11 – and he couldn't have found a more challenging spot in which to open his season.

Captain Crunch, a Captaintreacherous colt trained by Nancy Johansson for the 3 Brothers Stables, Christina Takter, the Rojan Stables, and Caviart Farms, won six of 10 starts, including the Breeders Crown at Pocono and the Governor's Cup, en route to divisional honors while winning the most money among baby colts, \$616,113, and coming within a fifth of his division's world record by winning in 1:49.1 at Lexington. Prepping for 2019, Captain Crunch has qualifying wins in 1:50.1 and 1:51.2 (the latter on a "good +1" track).

The draw was kind to Captain Crunch in one respect, as Scott Zeron will be guiding him from post three in the field of nine (all three divisions have nine starters). But the draw also gave Captain Crunch a real challenge, in that many of the section's top colts, at both two and three, will be lining up against him Sunday.

One example would be **Proof** (post eight, trainer Brian Brown, driver David Miller), second behind Captain Crunch in

last year's Breeders Crown, the 2018 Pennsylvania Sire Stakes champion, and a good second at The Meadows in the Sire Stakes' opening leg in his first start of the year; also in this cut is the horse who conquered Proof in that event in 1:50.4, **Southwind Ozzi** (post one, trainer Bill MacKenzie, one of four "calls" for driver Tim Tetrick). There's **Lyons Night Hawk** (post five, trainer Gareth Dowse, Tetrick also listed), who was just edged in 1:50.1 in a PA All-Stars event in his seasonal bow, and **Prince Of Tides** (post two, trainer Ross Croghan, driver Eric Carlson), 1:49.4 winner of the Wiggle It Jiggleit final at The Meadowlands.

But not all of the good horses will be facing Captain Crunch. In the 11th race third division, two sire stakes winners at The Meadows will attract a good deal of attention: Workin On A Mystery (post two, trainer Brian Brown, driver Tim Tetrick), who won the fastest Sires section in 1:50.1, and Love Me Some Lou, undefeated in two starts this year and a 1:50.4 Sires winner, who will have to negotiate the difficult post eight for trainer Tom Cancelliere and driver David Miller.

While the ninth race first division may not have horses who have some of the paper credentials of the other two divisions, it has some nice developing horses of its own, including **Major Deception** (post one, trainer Tony Alagna, driver Tim Tetrick), the easiest kind of winner at Philly over sloppy going in his 2019 return; **Wild Wild Western** (post two, trainer Norm Parker, driver Mike Wilder), who was second to Workin On A Mystery in the fastest PaSS division at The Meadows; and 2018 PA Fairs champion **Aflame Hanover** (post eight, trainer Linda Schadel, driver Tony Schadel), who has shown that he can be competitive with the most select of the state's three-year-olds.

There will also be four Pennsylvania Stallion Series divisions at Pocono Sunday, including first round StS winners Captain Koine, Skip To My Lou, and Under Paid, plus Captain Panko, the 2018 Stallion Series champion who will be making his 2019 debut.

First post for Sunday's 14 race card is set for 7 p.m.

Wilder's lifelong involvement with the sport and its players will make for interesting trackside and winner's circle interviews throughout the night.

Peter Kleinhans started going to Roosevelt Raceway as a teenager and his passion for the sport grew from there. Eventually he started training and driving his own stable and reached the top of the game.

Kleinhans was training a stable of 20 horses led by Enough Talk who was the first trotter in the world to break the 1:50 barrier when he won by over eight lengths in 1:49.3 at Colonial Downs in 2008. Enough Talk also won the Breeders Crown in 2010 and received the Dan Patch older trotter of the year trophy from USHWA in each of those two seasons.

Although he still competes as an amateur driver, Kleinhans has expanded his role in the sport to announcer, analyst and host and has recently filled in at the Meadowlands in those capacities. His knowledge and expertise of the sport and articulate delivery of same will provide an informative and entertaining look at the night's races for all who are watching.


