# Lawson: Ontario's Ministry of Health has failed horse racing

Despite the news that horse racing will return to Ontario on June 14, the CEO of the Woodbine Entertainment Group is still "highly frustrated" the sport has not been allowed to resume this Saturday along with golf, tennis, soccer and other outdoor sports.


For Jim Lawson, news that Ontario will allow horse racing to resume as of June 14 is just one tiny edible slice in an otherwise rancid pie.

"We'll accept June 14th, because we have to, and get on with life," the CEO of the Woodbine Entertainment Group said minutes before premier Doug Ford announced horse racing would be among activities allowed to resume IF 60 per cent of adults in Ontario have at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine by that date. Currently, 58.5 per cent of the adult population have received a first dose as of Thursday (May 20), but the province is waiting two weeks after hitting the 60 per cent target in order to monitor the vaccine outcome.

Lawson said horse racing should have been among the

outdoor activities such as tennis, golf, soccer and basketball that are permitted to resume as of this Saturday (May 22).

"The result defies logic," Lawson said. "It absolutely defies logic."

"I'm highly frustrated that the Ministry of Health did not take into account that we're outdoors, that we're masked, and that we're distanced – all of the things that they say that their science is telling them to reduce the risk of COVID transmission to a miniscule amount.

"We have all those factors and, not only that, but we have a great amount of our participants vaccinated. Also, there's our safety record. It's no coincidence that we've had a perfect safety record on the standardbred side and it's for the reasons I just said – we've been masked, we've been distanced, we've been outside, we've done the testing and we've monitored it. These are all the things that are in place, that aren't in place with golf and with tennis.

"I think it's a good thing that people can get outside and get exercise, for mental health and so on. For all of us, that's not the issue here. The Ministry of Health has failed to appreciate our factors, which I've gone over, as well as the mental health across a very, very large industry.

"This is not an acceptable approach by the government and it shows, I think, a lack of the ability to understand a very large industry and the safety record and all the factors that I said."

Lawson said he was "highly frustrated" with the Ministry of Health's classification of racing, without knowing for sure exactly how the Ministry has classified it.

"We just do not have a group at the Ministry of Health that has taken the time to listen and understand. I wish I could give you an answer for how they characterize racing. Do they think of it as a gambling industry or a casino industry? I wish I could give you an answer, but I don't even know that."

Lawson said he biggest concern has been the "short-term suffering" of those in the horse racing industry.

"People are hurting economically and it's hard to measure what impact it's going to have on the livestock and people being able to keep their head about water. They rely on the purses to keep going," he said. "The biggest thing is (delaying reopening until June 14) extends this suffering over a longer period than is necessary, so that's the first thing that comes to mind."

WEG has said it will resume standardbred racing at Woodbine Mohawk Park on June 14 and start its thoroughbred season at Woodbine Racetrack on June 18.

"I'm more worried on the thoroughbred side that we just may not be able to get the people to ship to Woodbine now," Lawson said. "That concerns me greatly because the impact of that — and it's hard to measure — is reduced wagering across the board and that impacts the Breeders Rewards for both breeds and the Woodbine thoroughbreds are a big driver of that. How many people are going to wait another three weeks because they get going?

"It could be damaging. I don't want to paint a really bleak picture, but I'm definitely concerned. I know people are suffering and this is not fair to them, because it's suffering that is unnecessary.

"I made that point to the premier's office today, you know, enough is enough. Between the Minister of Sport and the premier's office, we need a person that understands this file. This is too big of an industry for the Minister of Sport and other ministries in the premier's office, for us not to be in a position to speak to someone who understands this industry. We don't have the comfort that anyone in government really understands this industry and that's frustrating."

## **Last chance for Pompano Park**

It is looking increasingly likely that Florida casino interests will get their wish and be allowed to decouple from standardbred racing, putting the future of the state's lone harness track in jeopardy of closing after next year.

Why is consistently generating record handle not enough to keep a harness racetrack in business? Because the Florida casino gaming business urgently wants to be decoupled from harness racing. It may soon get its wish.

Dan Daley is the representative for Florida House District #97. If his name sounds familiar in a harness racing article, it should: "My dad — actually, we have the same name — races in the Northeast. He's stabled at Vernon; races in Canada, Ohio, Pennsylvania; and they also stable in Florida for six months of the year. So I grew up in Florida, in the industry. I actually grew up at what was Pompano Park, now known as The Isle. That's in my life. I know the industry better than probably anybody in this building."

The "building" Daley mentioned is the Florida State Capitol in Tallahassee. On Wednesday (May 19), he took a few minutes to explain what was currently at stake inside its doors.

"We are in a gaming special session, which means that we're meeting specifically on the issue of gaming, namely on a new Seminole compact with the Seminole Tribe in Florida." Daley said pari-mutuel standardbred racing was explicitly

threatened by Senate Bill 8-A put forward by Republican Senator Travis Hutson.

"One of the bills that was filed in addition to the compact is a bill that would essentially decouple standardbreds, quarter horses, and jai alai, but keep thoroughbreds protected."

The bill was to be voted on Wednesday afternoon. It revises "application requirements for an operating license to conduct pari-mutuel wagering for a pari-mutuel facility." Included in its wording are prohibitions on greyhound racing; authorization of jai alai, quarter horse racing and harness racing permit-holders "to elect not to conduct live racing or games," and a requirement that thoroughbred permit-holders conduct live racing.

Adding insult to injury, SB-8A allows permit-holders "that do not conduct live racing or games [to] retain their permit" to keep their slot machines. In the case of the state's only harness track, which is unnamed, "the harness horse racing permit holder, is eligible to be a host track for intertrack wagering and simulcasting and remains eligible for a cardroom license."

Isle Casino Pompano Park is conveniently grandfathered in by an amendment that restricts slots, table games, and simulcast wagering to venues which were licensed for pari-mutuel wagering in 2021/22. Barring a miracle, 2021/22 will be the last-ever season for live standardbred racing at Pompano, a fact recently mentioned in HRU by Caesars Entertainment senior vice president of racing Joe Morris.

Daley said he "took issue" with Senator Hutson's view that the Florida harness racing industry was "kind of 50/50 on whether they wanted to be decoupled," a quote that appeared in *Tampa Bay Times* coverage of Florida Senate Bill 7080 in April. Although that bill died April 30 because the calendar ran out, the same debate was revived in the special gaming session which began May 17. Daley said it was unimaginable that any harness racing participants were eager to end pari-mutuel racing, and "ironic" that Hutson would advocate for what could kill the state's standardbred industry "given that he's got the largest standardbred training centre in the country [Spring Garden Ranch] in his district, as well as seven or eight other standardbred farms."

Earlier this week, Daley's efforts caused short-lived

optimism that live harness racing would remain an essential requirement for Isle Casino Pompano Park's other gaming permits. The House Select Subcommittee on Authorized Gaming Activity approved HB-7A. On Monday, Republican House Representative Chris Latvala was quoted in *Florida Politics* as saying, "We are looking into the standardbred's issue and putting that back together" in the Senate bill.

By Wednesday morning, the situation was clearer, and sobering: "Senate has declined our amendment," Daley told HRU. "So I was able to get the House to agree to it; the House was going to protect standardbreds. The Senate would not take that amendment. And I had the votes in the Senate. They would not bring up my amendment to protect harness racing for consideration."

"So as it stands today [May 19], we are not in a good position, and barring something happening in the next couple of hours [Wednesday afternoon] that blows this whole thing up, which I don't foresee, or Governor DeSantis vetoing this bill, harness horses will be decoupled and it will essentially lead to the elimination of the industry in Florida."

Daley spoke with HRU before the vote on Senate Bill 8-A took place. "Later this afternoon [May 19], we're going to take up the Senate bill and we will vote on the Senate bill. The House is not letting me put the amendment on this bill, because the Senate is opposed to it." Why the opposition? "I couldn't tell you."

The Broward District representative noted that long-standing plans to redevelop Isle Casino Pompano Park into a multi-use property without racing were independent of the Senate vote. "That's the subject of an ongoing lawsuit," he added, "and I'm not so sure that they'll win that lawsuit. Regardless of the outcome of the lawsuit, for the most part, once decoupling goes through, they'll have no requirement to keep racing at the track.

"Now [Caesars] say, 'Oh well, don't worry, we're not going to get rid of it. We just don't want to be coupled.' If that was the case, why has The Isle filed a rezoning application to redevelop the property without a racetrack?

"It's been a fight that the casino operator has been bringing for years. Not Caesars specifically, but if you look back, ever since slots were approved at that property, they've been trying to starve off standardbred racing."

Pompano isn't in Daley's district, but it's in his blood.

"For years up here in Tallahassee, they've been pushing the decoupling idea, saying, 'Oh, harness racing is a dying industry. It's not as big and powerful and active as the thoroughbreds, so we can basically get rid of them.' That's essentially what's kind of been driving the boat, and I've been making the argument that it's not a dying industry: As a matter of fact, The Isle just hit a 57-year record in the history of harness racing in Florida, two weeks ago. In a 108-day season, they managed to move \$81 million in the handle."

How did Pompano still find itself in the line of fire, even after a record-breaking season of horseplayers answering announcer/director of racing Gabe Prewitt's call to #SendItIn?

"It comes down to money and influence, and standardbred horsemen and horsewomen are generally apolitical," said Daley. "They don't have a campaign war chest; they're not terribly politically active. Look at my father as an example: Look, he wants to race his horses, care for his horses—that's his life. He doesn't care about Tallahassee. He doesn't care about Washington D.C. He doesn't care about anything except his horses. And while that's admirable and amazing, it leads to situations like this, where somebody's coming for your livelihood and you're not as juiced as the next guy, and in this case, that next guy is the thoroughbreds.

"The thoroughbred breeders and all the ancillary groups that are connected to them have some significant juice in this state."

Although Ocala thoroughbred breeders have ensured that their sport is spared decoupling, *Florida Politics* reported this week that a representative for Gulfstream Park had (unsuccessfully) argued that if Pompano can decouple, it should be allowed to follow suit. Daley said that Florida thoroughbred horsepeople were not against standardbred peers sharing their protection under the Senate bill. "I've had conversations with them. They're not opposed to having us join them as coupled. They've not been pushing. It's not like they're throwing us under the bus."

Late Wednesday, Daley confirmed that events had played out as he expected.

"We took up the Senate version of the bill," he texted. "The House refused to add the amendment that they added to the House version to the Senate version today. This meant that the language still included decoupling of harness racing." (HB-7A specifies a pari-mutuel gaming license "requiring harness horse racing permit holders and thoroughbred permit holders to conduct live racing"; the same lines in SB-8A specify only "requiring thoroughbred permit holders to conduct live racing.")

He confirmed that there will be no additional sessions about the gambling bills, and no public referendum on decoupling.

The last possible chance for Pompano harness racing's survival is industry-wide grassroots advocacy.

"I think we shift our focus to the Governor," said Daley.
"Direct people to write to say, 'Mr. Governor, you are literally ending my business in Florida. Please veto this bill,' because that is the only way, after today." Time to #SendItIn, literally, to accomplish what millions of dollars wagered could not. Zero minutes to post is an understatement.

Governor DeSantis:

# Ontario owners gone, but not for good

When Woodbine Mohawk Park ceased racing on April 2, some owners sent horses to the U.S. pretty quickly, while others tried to hunker down and wait it out, but even they eventually had to give in.

For trainers with stables in both the U.S. and Canada, it wasn't too hard to send horses down to race at The Meadowlands, but for owners with purely Canadian-based trainers, temporary barn-hopping would be necessary.

"I held out as long as I could," said owner Brad Grant. "I didn't want to leave [trainer] Richard [Moreau], he's been great. I've had a tremendous amount of luck with Richard and we were hoping to wait it out, but after a while, you have to finally say 'Uncle'.

"I talked with Richard and he was the first one to say you've got to go. No hard feelings. I've told him when they get back racing [in Canada], I'll have horses back in his barn. There's no issue there."

Grant, who lives in Milton, ON, had always planned to send It's Academic, a 4-year-old trotter, to trainer Ron Burke in early April, but the overnight stablemates that made the trip with him were a different story.

"I really hemmed and hawed about doing it and finally I needed to race," said Grant. "I saw it with my overnighters

last time that they need to get themselves back in race shape. So being down for two months, it takes another two or three races before you feel that your horse is back to where he should be."

To be fair, Burke trains 300 horses and wasn't necessarily looking for more, but wanted to help Grant.

"How do you say no to Brad?" said Burke. "He's in a bad spot and I usually train his racehorses when they come south. If I was in the same spot, if I called him and said, 'I need to send them up there and you need to figure a way to get my horses raced,' he'd be like 'no problem.' Horsemen are very good that way. Nobody wants to see anybody else suffer."

In addition to It's Academic, who's in The Graduate Saturday night (May 22), Grant sent down five others, two of which are also racing at The Big M this weekend.

"The nice thing is that The Meadowlands will let me race multiple horses in a race," said Burke. "When a Brad horse beats one of my horses, it hurts a little bit but you've just got to do the right thing. Brad's been very good to us. He's bought a lot of horses off of us. He's great for the business and he's always available if you want to buy an expensive horse, he's in."

Burke has been contacted by other owners looking to send him horses and he's very nicely suggested other trainers.

"My first responsibility is to my people that are with me all year," said Burke. "Brad's here all year. He's part of the reason I have Atlanta. There are other great trainers in the United States that need an opportunity."

Canadian horsemen are enduring their third shutdown since the pandemic closed North America in March of 2020. The first one lasted about 11 weeks, the second was nearly

two months and this one could is predicted to go just over 10 weeks, with a resumption date of June 14 announced Thursday.

Brampton, ON resident, Mike Guerriero, co-owner of 8-year-old pacer Sintra, was planning on sending the gelding to race in the States, just not in late April.

"Would he have come down there [when he did] with the present circumstances not being what they are?" said Guerriero. "Probably not."

Sintra, who was trained in Canada by Anthony Beaton, is now in the care of Brett Pelling and is racing Saturday at The Meadowlands in the open-preferred handicap.

"We have to get him in condition," said Guerriero. "He's an old warhorse. He knows when he needs to turn it on and off. But racing against these other horses, if you're not prepared you have no chance.

"So, if we didn't do something when we did, we were going to be so far behind. They're going to start going in 1:47 and possibly 1:46. You can't expect a horse that's off a layoff for two months just to come into race shape in the first race or two and drop to those speeds."

Pelling agreed to take Sintra as a favor for a friend, but has turned down others because, just like almost every other U.S. trainer right now, he doesn't have enough staff to take care of a lot more.

"When a horse like Sintra comes along, he's a pretty cool dude, so how can you say no to him?" said Pelling. "I would love to have another half-a-dozen horses out of Canada, there are some good horses up there, but [being unable to get more staff] I just say no."

Tattoo Artist raced in The Graduate last week at The Meadowlands for co-owner Eric Cherry's Let It Ride Stables Inc. The 4-year-old is now pacing out of the Chris Ryder barn, which was totally part of his schedule.

"With Tattoo Artist it was planned that when he was in the U.S. he would be with Chris and when he was in Canada he was going to be with [Dr.] Ian [Moore]," said Cherry of Boca Raton, FL. "And the plans did change because of the Graduate and Confederation Cup and a few of the others when they canceled.

"What makes no sense to anybody is that if they have to train the horses and take care of the horses and no fans come to the racetrack, what difference does it make if they have the races? It doesn't make sense."

Trainer Nik Drennan has been racing horses in the U.S. for Canadian owner/trainer Donald Lindsey for 10 years. Lindsey, who co-owns most of his horses, won the William Haughton Memorial in 2011 at The Meadowlands with Alexie Mattosie trained by Drennan.

"Since me and Don and the partners have had this

relationship over the last 10 years, it's nothing out of the ordinary for them to send me horses, other than maybe that they'd send down one or two and now its five or six," said Drennan.

It's been an outstanding Meadowlands meet for Drennan, who is 10-for-45, due in part to Lindsey horses like Poseidon Seelster, who won a leg of The Graduate last week. Yacht Seelster is in a Big M overnight race tomorrow night.

"Don's the trainer and partial owner and his partners are like family, they're very close," said Drennan. "So, when Don says they're going back, they're going back. There's no me trying to keep the horses here or anything like that and it all works out really good. His partners are great and they send down really good horses and they're ready to race. It actually couldn't be any better."

It's impossible to know at this point what impact COVID-19 has had on Ontario's harness industry but it's not a stretch of the imagination to believe that they have lost owners along the way.

"I guess we're not going to know what the collateral damage is until racing gets going again and hopefully enough people will stick it out and we'll get back to some semblance of normalcy and get back to life as we knew it," said Grant. "It's expensive to operate a horse. And then to have the shutdowns where you have nothing but money going out and nothing coming in. At least when they're racing and nothing's coming in there's always next week. But right now, we don't know when next week is going to be. I see people that are selling and will continue to sell and won't be back. I think there are going to be a lot of faces around the racetrack that you're going to miss."

But Grant also sees the silver lining in the clouds that still hover in Ontario.

"We want to beat each other up on the track in every race but when hardship seems to fall on the industry, there are so many people there to support," he said. "I think a lot of people could have their noses out of joint with us coming down there and racing but I haven't heard it from anybody that I know that's down there and I think that speaks volumes of who the people are that are in the horse business."

Hail Mary in a runner up performance, Bazire had seen enough. Though Dorgos De Guez was invited to participate in the Elitloppet, Bazire will not bring the trotter to Sweden due to Swedish harness racing's rules.

Earlier, the entourage behind French-bred Elitloppet invitee Delia du Pommereux also said no to Solvalla and the 2021 Elitloppet due to the whipping penalty Raffin was handed at Åby.

As such, new names have been invited to compete in the Elitloppet.

Timo Nurmos trained, and American bred, Seismic Wave (Explosive Matter—Vanity Plates) made a strong runner up performance behind Heavy Sound at Solvalla last week and the 6-year-old gelding is now ready to battle against more merited trotters in the Elitloppet.

After the two French drop outs, 5-year-old Gelati Cut (Coktail Jet), trained by Romain Christian Larue, will participate under the French flag.

Johan Untersteiner's Cyber Lane (Raja Mirchi) has been close to participating in the Elitloppet in previous years and earned an invitation for this year's race after winning Sunday's (May 16) \$98,000 Copenhagen Cup in Denmark with



an impressive wire-to-wire victory in a mile rate of 1:54 over 1.3 miles. The victory at Charlottenlund was Cyber Lane's second triumph in Denmark's biggest international race. He also won the Copenhagen Cup in 2018, but that victory didn't qualify Cyber Lane for Elitloppet.

Cokstile (Quite Easy), who is title defender of the Elitloppet, seems to getting close to top shape at the moment and this week he received the pink ticket that tells that he is welcome to Solvalla next weekend.

Three spots remain before the Elitloppet is set. Here is the field, so far:

#### Prix de Paris winner best in Normandie


Richard Westerink's **Etonnant** (Timoko) impressed when he won the \$158,000 Prix des Ducs de Normandie in Caen, France on Wednesday (May 19) afternoon.

Driver Anthony Barrier used some of Etonnant's power shortly after the start and the duo hit the lead in the first turn. When in front, Etonnant and Barrier could dominate the race pretty much as they wanted.

Bazire's Davidson du Pont tried to challenge at the top of the stretch, but Etonnant was too strong over 2,450 meters (approximately 1.5 miles) and Anthony Barrier noted that he had everything under safe control at the end.

The mile rate of 1:53.2 over the actual distance is a strong achievement and it's clear that Etonnant belongs in the top among European trotters this season. During the winter meeting in Paris, the 7-year-old claimed an upset win in a Grand Prix race, the \$488,000 Prix de Paris, over 4,150 meters (approximately 2.6 miles). Wednesday's Prix des Ducs de Normandie must have felt like a mile race for the strong trotter.







## Multi-sport athlete Marianna Monaco has powerful emotions when it comes to her pacing mare

The emotion in Marianna Monaco's voice is unmistakable. With each word she speaks, the more tears – happy ones – the 25-year-old New Yorker sheds.

The reason behind the heartfelt reaction comes in the form of a brown mare, a pacer by the name of Powerful Pulse.

Now 11, the daughter of Quick Pulse Mindale has racked up nearly 50 wins in almost 280 career starts, a hard-knocking campaigner with over \$275,000 in her bankroll and plenty of miles traveled, on and off the racetrack.

Monaco owns the Winbak Farm-bred miss, initially a \$2,000 purchase at the 2011 Harrisburg Yearling Sale.

"I bought her about three months ago," said Monaco. "I originally had her about two years ago before she was claimed and I recently bought her back. I didn't pay a lot for her. I wasn't sure what to expect with her, but I thought to myself, 'She's older and I've had her before.' I figured it was worth the shot, for only \$2,000. She made me quite a bit of money racing at Monticello a few years ago. And now, here we are."

She also owns Haymitch, a 5-year-old pacing son of Roddys Bags Again.

"I bought him around seven months ago. The last few months have been a rollercoaster with him, to say the least. It's nice to get him back, get a few starts under his belt and get him back to his old self again."

For Monaco, both are the epitome of true athletes: dedicated to their craft, determined to compete, and always willing to go the extra mile.

She would know a thing or two about those traits.

Monaco is an accomplished multi-sport athlete, including her numerous successes on the golf course.

In 2017, she drove and putted her way to the New York State Women's Amateur golf championship, one year after finishing second in the event. She won consecutive Women's Dutchess County Amateur titles starting in 2019 and 2020.

But her sporting accomplishments don't end on the fairways and greens. Monaco is also a standout bowler and softball player.

"Growing up, I played a lot of different sports. In high school, I was an all-state bowler, and bowled on the varsity team from seventh grade up until my senior year. I was on the New York state team that made it to the championship all six years. I stopped bowling after high school, when I was averaging about 215. I also played travel fast pitch softball. I played varsity softball. I had a lot of offers to Division 1 U.S. colleges – full rides – but in my sophomore year of high school, my dad and I talked about there not being much for softball after college. And that's when I picked up golf."

Monaco received a full scholarship to play at Newberry College (South Carolina), where she earned South Atlantic Conference Freshman of the Year honors and, was named SAC Player of the Year as a sophomore. She transferred to the University of South Carolina for her final two years and graduated four years ago with a degree in criminal justice. All of those experiences, she offered, have helped in her horse racing career. She has had a long association with the

industry.

Monaco started jogging horses at an early age. Her father, Nick, owned horses and she's had other family members in

the industry over the years.

"Playing different sports allows you to be put in different situations every time you play. Mentally, especially with golf, it can be very draining. It's just you and your brain... you learn something new every day. With golf, you can shoot a 65, come off the course and think that you left a few shots out there. I think with the horses, it's the same thing. You learn something new about each horse every day – what they like, what they don't, what benefits them most, what sets them back – and working with them, I realize how much other sports helped me with this career."

Monaco recorded her first driving win in 2018 at Goshen Historic Track, a win made even sweeter considering it came on her 23rd birthday. She registered her first pari-mutuel triumph in 2020 in the GSY Amateur Series at The Meadowlands, and completed her campaign with six scores.

Add a Billings Amateur Series victory at Yonkers to her stat line, and the decision to carve out a life in the Standardbred industry has been a winning one for Monaco.

"They are long days, but they are rewarding days. This industry, you appreciate early on just how much of a rollercoaster it can be. When they say that it's in your blood, it definitely is. When I went away to school for four years and came back, I got right back into the business. I haven't looked back since."

She's looking forward to even better days.

"It's a learning process, in how you get to understand each horse. But at the same time that I'm teaching them, they're also teaching me. It's definitely a team effort."

Having a teammate like Powerful Pulse makes striving for success a simple task.

"I remember I went home the day I was buying her back. I told my dad that she was coming back to me. She had just raced that day, and she came first over against a horse that ended up racing in a bigger series at Yonkers. They went 1:56.2 and she was seventh. My dad said, 'Where are you going to race this horse? What do you think will you get out of this?' I sat on her for a few weeks and I looked where I thought she's fit best."

Monaco's voice then starts to tremble slightly.

"She's kind of amazed me so far. Every week, I look forward to racing her. The text I get after she races, the different Facebook posts, the calls I get... people are really kind and tell me what I've been able to do with her is amazing.... it makes me emotional. I'm just very fortunate to be connected to her and to be doing something that I truly love."

# Uncut Gem poised to sparkle in tonight's Indiana Sires Stakes opener

Tonight (May 21), the opening round of Indiana Sires Stakes kicks off at Harrah's Hoosier Park, and if the series action leading up to this weekend is any indication, the competition will be stout. Jon Taylor, Steve Amspaugh and Eric Demalon will be trackside to cheer on their racing interest Uncut Gem. Together, they have partnered on a filly that last week captured the \$22,000 Go On BB final with a 1:51.1 performance. Tonight, the Wilbur Eash trainee looks to sparkle in the evening's second race, a \$49,000 division.

"She's pretty much right on her schedule," said Eash. "I kind of wanted her to shine a little bit heading into the sires stakes. I think we're right at that point. I'm happy with where she is at right at the moment."

Eash has his charge ready for action, and the owners behind the JK Endofanera—Straight Fuel lass couldn't be more excited. Taylor, who is Eash's step-son, has grown up around the business and knows the ups and downs associated with racing. His partners, however, are relatively new to the game, but have strong connections to the 45 year old. Amspaugh is the uncle of Taylor's wife, and harness racing is part of his lineage.

"We used to race horses back in the 50s and 60s. We used to have a stud horse that had a record of 2:01 and we used him for breeding," Amspaugh said.

Taylor said that during family get-togethers in Ohio, Amspaugh would inquire about racing, and kept up to date on the horses in Eash's stable. In late 2017, the two

partnered on No Chaser, a mare purchased out of the Harrisburg sale. They raced her for one season before she began broodmare duties.

Demalon, on the other hand, had no connection to racing prior to November 2019. He and Taylor both worked at Charles Schwab for more than 20 years and developed a friendship during that time. Demalon had casually attended races at Hoosier Park, but had never felt the urge to take the plunge into racing. All that changed with a filly cataloged as Maddie K in the Hoosier Classic sale.

"She was supposed to go through the Hoosier sale but she got sick. Dad and I both had her circled to look at. We didn't get to see her at that time," Taylor said. "It worked out we didn't get one bought that year at the sale. Later she came up on ongait."

The filly turned out to be the fifth foal from a Third Straight mare that had just under \$20,000 on her card. However, Straight Fuel came from a strong family. Her dam, the No Nukes mare Armbro Kerosene, produced 11 winners from 13 foals with five six-figure earners led by Indiana Sires Stakes champion and 40-time winner Rocket Fuel p,3, 1:50.1m; 7, 1:50m (\$784,006).

"I like to go back and make sure there is some production in the family. Conformation is usually where I start. If I don't like that, I don't care how well a horse is bred, I move on," Eash said of the characteristics he looks for in a horse. "Her appearance is really a standout. She looks good body-wise. It's a good family. I just liked the way she stood."

Taylor approached his soon-to-be partners on the filly. After turning away requests in the past, Demalon finally said yes. Amspaugh also joined in on his second racehorse. Taylor and Demalon and some friends came up with a list of 25 potential names for Maddie K. They settled on a name taken from the title of an Adam Sandler movie.

"We had anything and everything under the sun," explained Taylor. "Separately, Eric ranked his in order from his favorite to least favorite and I did the same, and we took the best average from both of our lists. That's what we went with, and fortunately it was available. At the time we did this Uncut Gems had just been released."

As a freshman, Uncut Gem made 11 starts for Eash and the partnership. She managed one win and finished second three

times, twice in Indiana Sires Stakes action. She took a mark of 1:53.4 with Joey Putnam as her driver, and earned \$36,475. The filly was high strung, and Eash was more concerned about developing a good three year old than putting her on the front end each time out.

"I told them, 'I won't let her go too far. If we send this filly one time, I'll have my hands full. She's very sensitive," Eash said of the 2020 campaign. "We just took her back most of the time. We raced her, but just kept it conservative."

Taylor had watched this play out before with a young Beckhams Z Tam. Eash raced the colt six times at two and shut him down in late August with his sights set on the 2017 season. That year, the son of Always A Virgin went on to win 11 times, including a triumph in the \$527,500 Breeders Crown for three-year-old pacing colts.

"Dad's a pretty straight shooter when it comes to providing information. He said she had speed, she showed speed. We didn't have to do any vet work on her and she stayed sound," noted Taylor. "We came up with a plan to get her qualified and get a couple of races under her belt to see if she was sires stakes worthy. We didn't want to over-race her. That's one thing that dad's really good at, taking care of his horses."

In five attempts this season, Uncut Gem has registered two wins and a pair of runner-up finishes. Sent off at odds of 20-1 in the opening leg of the Go On BB, Putnam steered the filly to a second-place finish, sprinting home with a :26 last quarter. Favored the next week, she scored a 1:54.3 triumph in the second leg. In the May 13 final, Putnam placed her on the front after the quarter and the duo never looked back, winning by two lengths in her fastest mile to date. Eash attended a wedding that night and was not on hand for the victory, but the partnership was there in full force.

"This doesn't happen to everybody. You could probably buy 10 horses to get one like Uncut Gem," said Amspaugh. "She's only my second horse. It's been a very big surprise, especially with how fast they go now."

Taylor has worked hard to manage expectations, first with an inexperienced freshman and now with a sophomore that has provided flashes of ability. This summer Uncut Gem will have to face the likes of Somethingbeautiful, last year's Pacer of the Year in Indiana, and Hot Mess Express, a 1:50 winner last week at the Meadowlands, as well as several other fast fillies. Tonight, those pacers battle in the second division, slated as Race 9 on the program.

"Jon has asked me for several years off and on, and I kind of took the plunge not knowing what to expect, but it's beyond my wildest dreams. Going up there and realizing you have a

horse in the race, it's very exciting. Myself, my wife and my son, we're all in. We love it," added Demalon, who is already planning to reinvest at the yearlings sale this fall.

The contenders will separate themselves from the pretenders over the next few rounds of Indiana Sires Stakes competition. Will Uncut Gem dazzle when tested? For now, her connections are thrilled with the experience and the prospects of more excitement to come.

"They're on cloud nine. I am too. I am for them," Taylor said. "She's started out this season well. We're just now getting into the competitive part of it, the hard racing is just getting started."

# **USTA** introduces Official's Internship Training Program

The U.S. Trotting Association, in conjunction with the Minnesota Racing Commission, Running Aces Racetrack, Kentucky Racing Commission, and Red Mile Racetrack, announced Monday (May 17) the introduction of a new Official's Internship Training Program kicking off on May 30.

The first participant will be longtime Illinois harness horseman John Zawistowski, known as "Johnny Z" to many in the industry, who comes highly recommended by Meadows Standardbred Owners Association executive director and former USTA director Kim Hankins.

At the conclusion of the Official's Internship Training Program, Zawistowski will immediately join the staff of judges at Red Mile as an associate judge under the supervision of Red Mile presiding judge Tim Schmitz.

"The USTA Board of Directors have been concerned about the decline of qualified officials so they budgeted money to create this program," said USTA COO TC Lane, who is being assisted in its administration by USTA racetrack operations manager Michele Kopiec. "This internship will fulfill our commitment to the industry by supplying tracks with highly trained racing officials at no extra cost to the states or tracks. Our goal is to expand this program in the future.

"We could not execute this without lots of assistance from others in the industry. The USTA and I would like to thank Minnesota Racing Commission executive director Steve May, Running Aces judges Bob Corey (presiding) and Mike Hall, the Kentucky Racing Commission executive director Marc Guilfoil and Red Mile presiding judge Tim Schmitz for their important participation."

Zawistowski's training at Running Aces will take place from May 30 through July 2. The curriculum is extensive and includes hands-on experience in the judges stand, race office, paddock, test barn and in hearings with instruction about



mutuels, teletimer, photo finish, race charting, horse identification, security, licensing and conducting a draw.

In addition, as a requirement, he will also attend the Racing Officials Accreditation Program (ROAP) this summer from July 12-19 to expand his licensure. Both Lane and Kopiec serve on the board of directors for the ROAP.

"A couple of years ago, I was approached about being a judge, so I had been thinking about it," said Zawistowski. "I just turned 60 and was looking for an easier way to stay in the business. Then I got injured and had rotator cuff and bicep surgery in January.

"I'm at The Meadows and heard about the USTA program from Kim Hankins who has been a good friend for over 40 years. He talked to TC (Lane) at the USTA then I talked with my wife about this opportunity, and we said, 'let's do this."

"In this inaugural program, we've planned a month-long training period with an extensive curriculum to see how it goes with the idea that we can make adjustments if necessary in the future," concluded Lane.

# 'Cuatro' goes forth after winter of changes

After an offseason of adjustments, Cuatro De Julio put his best foot forward in his seasonal debut last week, winning a division of the New Jersey Sire Stakes (NJSS) for 3-year-old male trotters at The Meadowlands. His connections hope for a repeat performance in tonight's (May 21) second round of the series at The Big M.

Cuatro De Julio won nine of 14 races last year, when his best time of 1:51.3 ranked second to only Southwind Tyrion's world-record 1:51.1 among all 2-year-old trotters. The mercurial colt finished second once and went off stride in his remaining four losses.

During this past winter, trainer Marie Ortolan Bar's goal was to stabilize Cuatro De Julio's racetrack temperament. First, she bought a pacer named Shoot Me Straight to jog and train with Cuatro De Julio. The trotter, who was accustomed to working alone, slowly adjusted to having a companion.

"In the beginning, he would not stay next to him. Impossible," Ortolan Bar said. "It took one month for (Cuatro De Julio) to accept him. But now he doesn't want to go on the track without his friend. He learned to be with another one."

In addition, Ortolan Bar experimented with different bits and bridles. After watching Cuatro De Julio qualify at Miami Valley Raceway in 1:54.1 and win by 23 lengths on April 14, she decided to have the horse race with an open bridle for the first time in last week's NJSS.

"It was important to fix the problem," said Ortolan Bar, who has had a **special relationship with the homebred colt** from his earliest days. "We have to control him. After the qualifier, I had to find some solution. I found it, but it took time. He does not like a lot. The more you try to control him, the more he fights with you. You have to find a way to put something comfortable on him and be relaxed.

"Sometimes, he can be so adorable, but when he gets mad, he wants to control everything. They say he is crazy. I say no. He is crazy talented. You have to just understand him. Is he special? Yes. Is he difficult? Yes. But we will try to find a solution."

Cuatro De Julio is 6-5 on the morning line in the second of two \$25,000 New Jersey Sire Stakes divisions on Friday. The colt will start from post seven in a field of eight with Lucas Wallin in the sulky. Wallin last week was a late sub for driver Louis Baudron, who was unable to travel from France.

Ortolan Bar selected Wallin for the assignment because she thought he would be a good fit with her horse. The 28-year-old Wallin was a successful driver in Europe and the U.S. before

spending recent years focused on his own training stable.

"He has talent and there is no stress in him," Ortolan Bar said. "With this horse, he is a perfect match because he is quiet. I know a catch driver is important. They do it every day. They are good. But Lucas, he did not forget how to be a good driver. So, why not? He goes very well with my horse. And I love to share this horse. I know for the future of these kids, I have to give them a chance."

Wallin, who guided Cuatro De Julio to a 1:53.1 score last week, was grateful.

"It was an experience I'll remember for a long, long time," Wallin said. "First of all, he's a very nice colt. He showed that plenty of times last year. And it's good for your own development and experience to drive horses like that.

"I'm very thankful that they trust me and let me drive him. (Breeder/owner) Jean Pierre Dubois is a legend everywhere, so just to drive a race for him is big. And to give him a win was even sweeter. The horse had some issues last year, he was a little bit too aggressive and grabby, but they did a really good job with him in the winter. He was very nice to drive last week. I hope he is the same on Friday."

Cuatro De Julio is among 14 Hambletonian-eligible horses in tonight's NJSS for the male trotters. The \$1 million Hambletonian Stakes is Aug. 7 at The Meadowlands.

The 7-2 second choice in the second NJSS division is Ake Svanstedt-trained Mon Amour, who also was bred by Dubois and raised by Ortolan Bar. He finished second to Cuatro De Julio last week. Locatelli, trained by Nancy Takter, is the 2-1 favorite in the first division.

The \$200,000 series final is May 28.

There also are two divisions of the NJSS for 3-year-old female trotters tonight at The Meadowlands. Eazy Pass is the 2-1 favorite in the first division while Beltassima is the 3-1 favorite in the second division.

### Thebeachiscalling, Always B First in 1:50 in PASS

The second choice came through in each of the three divisions of the first preliminary of the Pennsylvania Sire Stake (PASS) for 3-year-old pacing fillies Wednesday afternoon (May 19) at Harrah's Philadelphia, on a card which also featured seven Stallion Series sections.

First to Victory Lane was the Somebeachsomewhere miss **Thebeachiscalling**, who had earned \$161,196 without winning in the first 10 starts of her career, but built on a winning effort last week to take her PASS event in a new mark of 1:50 for owner Bella Racing LTD. The winner was first on top but then saw Grace Hill and then favored Blue Diamond Eyes go by her past the :26.4 quarter, with the latter carrying on to a fast :54.1 half and a 1:21.4 three-quarters, nearing which Thebeachiscalling was taken outside to challenge by driver Andrew McCarthy.

McCarthy's filly, trained by Chris Ryder, moved powerfully on the turn into contention, and in the stretch the more heralded fillies to her left were not her main competition, but one to her right was – Mikala, a neck behind "Calling" in an overnight last week, and finishing strongly again only to miss by the same margin. Blue Diamond Eyes were third, a half-length further behind, with Grace Hill another neck behind that one.

Next to the winner's circle was the Sweet Lou filly **Continualou**, in her first race since winning the Matron last November. David Miller went to the top with the filly and got "soft" fractions of :27,:55.4, and 1:23.3, which left her having plenty in the tank to see off the uncovered move of favored JK Alwaysbalady by three-quarters of a length in 1:51. Ron Burke trains the versatile filly for Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Bruscemi LLC.

In the third section, **Marsala Hanover** was dispatched as the favorite, but the filly found grinding from fifth a bit too much as the Always B Miki filly Always B First moved out for Yannick Gingras past a :27.1 quarter to make the lead well before a :55 half, and then passed the three-quarters in 1:22.3. From there Always B First was able to withstand the chalk by a length in a mile in 1:50, her best clocking. The winner has now taken four of her last five races for trainer Robert Cleary and the partnership of Oompa's Farm Inc., Robert Mondillo, Craig Henderson, and Allen Wenc.

In the Stallion Series competition, six of the seven winners took new lifetime marks (we'll mention the one who "just" equaled hers). Dexter Dunn drove three winners, one of them for trainer Ryder named **Podium Girl**, who closed in 26.4 to win in 1:51.1 for Henderson Farms, Robert Mondillo, and Barry Spak. Dunn also won with the Artspeak filly **Filly Speaks** in 1:52 for trainer Scott Betts and owners Timothy Betts, Nicholas Catalano, and Keith Pippi, and with the Captaintreacherous filly **Classicist**, a 1:52.2 winner for trainer Tahnee Camilleri and owner David Kryway.

"Team Orange Crush," trainer Julie and driver Andy Miller, have been on a roll lately, and they had two Stallion Series successes: with the Always B Miki miss **So Miki Hanover**, up the inside to win in 1:52.1 for owners Michael Cimaglio, A And B Stable, and Charles Elliott, and with **Tonianne**, a daughter of Somebeachsomewhere who equaled the 1:52.4 mark she took two starts back for Andy Miller Stable Inc. and Louis Willinger.

Driver David Miller, who joined trainer Ryder as winners in both the Sire Stakes and Stallion Series, had the fastest winner in the latter grouping, the Sweet Lou filly **Chase Lounge**, who at 9-1 was the biggest-paying stakes horse of the day while scoring in 1:51 for owner William Hartt and trainer Roland Mallar. Completing the list of stakes success was the Somebeachsomewhere filly **Staycation Hanover**, who won the last race in 1:51.3 for owner David Mc Duffee, trainer Brett Pelling, and driver Todd McCarthy – 4 hours and 46 minutes after Todd won the first race of the day.

FINISHING LINES – Trainer Scott Di Domenico, among the top 10 trainers at Philly, tied for first at Freehold, and second at Yonkers, harnessed the 2,000th winner of his career Tuesday night (May 18) at Yonkers when Maroma Beach won. Di Domenico-trained horses have amassed almost \$30 million, and Scott has a lifetime win ratio just north of 17 per cent... After the usual hard-hitting "Trottin' Thursday" card at Philly, PA-sired 3-year-old fillies will be featured today (May 21), this time the trotters, with most of the divisional leaders from last year being joined by 2021 sensation Bella Bellini. ## Abuckabett Hanover photos Perfect Sting In 1:50 in Pocono PASS

**Abuckabett Hanover** took away the undefeated status of 2-year-old champion Perfect Sting, but both colts lost nothing of their lofty reputations at the end of a 1:50 mile, the fastest of three divisions of the second preliminary of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes (PASS) for 3-year-old pacing colts during the Sunday (May 16) twilight card at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

Lou's Pearlman took advantage of the rail to put Summa Cum Laude in the pocket by the :27.3 quarter, only soon to see Perfect Sting and then Abuckabett Hanover sweep past to the lead by a :56.1 half. The field went to the three-quarters in 1:23.3, and then the afterburners were turned on, with Abucketabett Hanover coming home in :26.2 for Andrew McCarthy to finish a head better than Perfect Sting, who in his seasonal debut came home individually in :53.3 - :26.

Abuckabett Hanover, a Betting Line colt who was 3-5 in the betting vs. Perfect Sting's 6-5, had the advantage of a race before the Pocono mile, winning in 1:49.1 at The Meadowlands, and he will be major force in the division for trainer Tony Alagna and the ownership of Crawford Farms Racing, Alagna Racing LLC, Jablonsky Held Stable, and Barbera N Wienick Stable.

One Eight Hundred made a huge blast out of the pocket (own last split :26.1) to overhaul Southwind Gendry in a 1:50.3 PASS victory for driver Tim Tetrick and driver Nancy Takter, the latter co-owner with Brixton Medical Inc. This race also featured two front-stretch brushes after the quarter (:27.2), first by One Eight Hundred and then by Southwind Gendry, who had been three-wide early and never saw the rail until the three-eighths.

"Gendry," a 1:49.4 PASS winner in his 2021 bow, put up middle fractions of :56.2 and 1:24.1 then came home in :26.3 himself, but he could not withstand a monstrous last eighth by One Eight Hundred, a Somebeachsomewhere colt who now has four wins in five seasonal starts, all at Pocono. One Eight Hundred and Southwind Gendry were both 7 to 5, with the former the favorite and a three-quarters of a length winner.

The third PASS division also went in 1:50.3, with trainer Tony Alagna picking up a second Sires win with the Somebeachsomewhere colt **Exploit**, who lowered his mark a tick. Joe Bongiorno sent the favored colt up grinding against pacesetter Gamblin Mo, who moved to the lead after a :27.1 opener and hung midrace splits of :56 and 1:23.3, with

Exploit showing his grit by pacing his own last half in :53.4 raw to overhaul the leader by a head for Leblanc and Kribbs, Joe Sbrocco, In The Gym Partners, and Joseph Barbera.

There were also seven divisions of the second Stallion Series prelims, which unusually generated seven gelding winners. Sire Somebeachsomewhere, trainer Brett Pelling, and the McCarthy brothers accounted for three winners; Todd's victories coming with **Komodo Beach** in a new mark of 1:51.3 for David McDuffee, John Fodera, Steven Wienick, and Trevor Ritchie (this triumph was by 1½ lengths, the largest margin of all ten Sunday Pocono stakes), and with **South Beach Star** in 1:51.1 for All Star Racing Inc., while Andrew guided Whichwaytothebeach home first in 1:51.2 for Alan Johnston and John Craig.

Another multiple siring credit went to Sweet Lou; his winning offspring were **Straight Talk** in 1:52.1 for driver David Miller, trainer Ron Burke, and the ownership of Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Bruscemi LLC, William Switala, and James Martin, and also **Boiler Maker**, who reduced his mark to 1:51.4 for driver Tim Tetrick, trainer Jim King Jr., and Tim Tetrick LLC.

The fastest Stallion divisional winner was **Lindycalledfrankie**, by Captaintreacherous, who lowered his record to 1:51 for driver Scott Zeron, trainer Linda Toscano, and owner Arnie Chusid. Completing the StS winners was a son of Always B Miki, **Always B Sweet**, who was a 7-1 upsetter in a lifetime best of 1:51.3 for driver Andrew McCarthy and the brother team of trainer John and owner Tom Cancelliere.

How competitive are these 3-year-olds going to be this year? Here's one indication: Not one of Sunday's Pocono winners was also victorious in the first SS/StS preliminary held at The Meadows 15 days ago.
