NESTOR CORTES makes a pitch for harness racing with a standardbred on his cleats



just any harness horse, as was first covered in the *Yankees Beat* **newsletter**, a horse named Tam Major A. Cortes owns a piece of the \$370,000-winning pacer that raced at The Meadowlands last Saturday (May 13), the same day Cortes started against the Rays at Yankee Stadium. Cortes received a no-decision that day in the Yankees' 9-8 win and has since improved his record on the year to 4-2 with a solid win earlier this week against Toronto. He is the latest in a string of professional athletes to illustrate a direct interest towards harness racing.

Cortes grew up in close proximity to Florida thoroughbred racetracks Hialeah Park and Gulfstream Park and introduction into standardbreds is largely the result of his relationship with Joe Lee, who in addition to full-time work as a financial advisor, is an assistant equipment manager with the Yankees and is also recognized in harness racing circles as one of the more accomplished amateur drivers in the sport over the past few years. The idea of Cortes becoming involved in a horse with Lee is something that had been kicked around for a little while.

"[Cortes] wanted to get involved last year and I just hadn't claimed anything yet," Lee said. "He always said to let him know though and maybe he'd take a piece. So, after the offseason and once spring rolled around, [trainer/co-owner] Buzzy Sholty and I claimed this horse Tam Major that had been racing well. And so, Nestor had been wearing a pair of custom cleats for each start this year. He has an artist that does the side of his cleats, and he had me send a picture of what a harness horse would look like on the track. The artist who makes them up then forwards them to Nestor at the stadium a couple of days later for his next start and that's how that came to be."

Following the Yankees' win earlier that day, Cortes, along with teammate Jimmy Cordero and other friends, attended The Meadowlands in person to watch Tam Major race.

A \$30,000 claim from April 22, Tam Major won his first start off the claim for his new connections on April 29 in a n/w \$10,500 conditioned race. He worked his way up the class ladder maybe a bit too high as of May 13, though Tam Major lost only by four lengths in a n/w \$20,000 race with Cortes taking in the races from one of The Meadowlands' skyboxes.

Cortes isn't the first Yankee in recent memory to have a brush with harness racing. Yankees general manager Brian Cashman, the son of harness racing Hall of Famer John Cashman, Jr., often comes to The Meadowlands to present the trophy for the John Cashman Memorial.

Though perhaps more 'accidental,' just last fall Yankees star and American League MVP Aaron Judge regularly sported a Siegelman Stable branded hat, which features a horse and sulky.

"When [Judge] started wearing that hat in the playoffs last October, he was wearing it for the design and brand," said Lee, who added with a laugh, "But I was getting phone calls from all over the country when he was doing his post-game interviews asking if he was with the Siegelman Stable, if he had bought into some standardbreds; I even had Brian Cashman call and ask if he bought a horse with me. Judge was just wearing a brand at that time and there's other guys wearing those hats around the clubhouse now, too. Harrison Bader, Judge, Giancarlo Stanton's wearing one and they all get it now, Nestor shows everyone the races."

Lee's prominence as a driver in amateur harness races has been of interest within some Yankees clubhouse circles. The competitiveness of racing is something that's highly relatable for professional athletes.

"A lot of the guys will ask me when I'm driving and there's a good handful of them that always want to see replays of my races, so I think that's turned them on a bit," Lee said. "Driving in these races has sparked spurts of interest into what I'm doing and it's translated into now where Nestor is involved, who loves it and maybe others down the road."

Interestingly, whereas Lee and amateur races have acted as a catalyst in expanded involvement, amateur racing taking front and center stage at The Meadowlands has been an area of contention. To some, amateur races — and being carded to the extent that they are — is a drawback to pari-mutuel racing. In complete contrast, Lee wholeheartedly sees amateur racing as a proven positive for the sport.

"I absolutely believe that the amateur races have a place on the cards," Lee said. "At this point they've been carded for quite a while for a number of years and it's been well received by the overwhelming public. Week in and week out amateur races are some of the highest — if not the highest — bet races on The Meadowlands card. I would say about four or five weeks ago we had two amateur races on the Friday night card and



both the exacta and trifecta pools handled north of \$90,000. And there wasn't a single race on that Friday or Saturday night where those pools even hit over \$70,000. And with the struggle today for race secretaries to fill cards and have full fields, The Meadowlands is a premier place and one where you can still have 10 horses across the gate. Last week there were just five full fields out of a 14-race card and the amateurs supported three of them: that in itself allows for better handle."

The main argument against amateur racing is that the betting product becomes too unpredictable, due to the inexperience of the drivers. But, as Lee notes, the fact that amateur racing consistently produces some of the highest handle races regardless of which track they race at, quells the argument that the races are too unpredictable to wager on. In fact, the style of racing produced by the amateurs is the total opposite of the boring, speed-favoring racing that those on the other side of the argument take issue with.

"I think years ago amateur racing was a bit different when it was more like a good old boys club, to be honest with you," Lee said. "It was seen as a crash derby, whereas today there's so much amateur racing in the Northeast and a lot of these guys like myself, Tony Verruso, are driving quite a few races. It's just a different dynamic. There could be guys out there at 10-1 or 15-1 on the lead and then here comes a 4-5 favorite in the race and they're not afraid to park a guy. They then get down to the half a little quick, they could tire in the stretch and then you're setting it up for horses to come zooming by that wouldn't have figured otherwise. The average win price in the amateurs is way higher than the win and exotic prices than the rest of the card. But then you'll have others who don't like it when every horse that wins is 2-5. You can't have it both ways.

"But, I really do think it's been well received. And nobody takes for granted that we'll always be able to race each week but between Jeff Gural and Jason Settlemoir they've been gracious enough to let us do it. There've been a couple of incidents in our races, but there've been incidents in the regular races too. You obviously try to be as safe as you can out there and for the most part, I think the races have been pretty clean. It's a bright spot for racing and it gets more people involved. It really helps the sport for sure."

Tom Pollack's journey from fan to top owner

If asked to name the most well-known owners of racehorses in the sport — those who likely have made the greatest investment in it — the list would undoubtedly be headed by the Burke/ Weaver Bruscemi tandem followed by Howard Taylor and then maybe Brad Grant. I'm probably missing someone or several. Right up there with those luminaries would undoubtedly be the Pittsburgh-area owner Tom Pollack along with his trainers Jeff Cullipher and Randy Bendis.

Pollack's present roster of horses in training numbers 118. When one regularly checks horses racing at The Meadowlands,

Harrah's (both in Indiana and Pennsylvania), Pocono Downs, Northfield and Oak Grove — basically wherever harness races take place and where his horses fit into the racing schedule you will find Pollack's horses racing. Some may think that Pollack is a fairly new arrival on the scene. He certainly has not been involved for as long as those previously mentioned. However, he has been involved, first as a fan in the late 1980s, and then as an owner beginning in 2009. Hehas been buying more and more horses since then.

You obviously love the sport. How did it all begin?

"I first went to the track as a teenager. I wasn't particularly interested at the time. Ive always enjoyed sports, pretty much all sports. Harness racing was nowhere near the top. Initially I didn't see what might have been so appealing about watching a group of horses going round and round. A friend of mine John Campbell [not that John Campbell] had horses racing at The Meadows with Randy Bendis. He and his wife Janet loved the sport. They still do and are still quite involved. John convinced me that it might be fun to own a horse together with his trainer. We bought a trotter, Raps Legacy, and did quite well with him initially. We bought several horses after him and hit a drought. It didn't matter much that we were not doing well. I was hooked."

You are probably most associated with trainer Jeff Cullipher, but you are also still with Randy Bendis after all these years. To stay with the first trainer you had for almost 15 years is somewhat of a rarity in the sport.

"Yes. I still own 25 horses with Randy and now I am approaching somewhere near a hundred with Jeff. Randy races mostly at The Meadows, sometimes wandering to Ohio or elsewhere in Pennsylvania. Being with Randy allows me to have a hometown presence, which I really enjoy. I live near Mark Weaver and have become good friends with him. I doubt that I will ever have the number of horses that he has, but as the man selling lottery tickets says, 'You never know.'"

How did your association with Cullipher come about?

"We had a 3-year-old trotting filly, BJs Elegant Image, eligible to the Indiana Sires Stakes. We sent her to Jeff and she won and won and won. When I initially met him, we hit it off. We are both about the same age and have a similar love for racing. As fate would have it, Jeff didn't have many in his stable at the time. He was seriously thinking of leaving the business. I told him how passionate I was about the business, I loved it and really wanted to grow. Fortunately, he had the same passion and ambition and we've been together ever since."

You've owned a lot of horses. Do you have any idea how many? Do you have any favorites?

"I'm guessing that we've owned somewhere in the area of 700. My favorite is probably Wisdom Tree. She swept the New York Sire Stakes, earned \$687,376 and took a record of 1.49.1. She is now a broodmare for us. Her first foal is a filly by JK Endofanera that arrived a few days ago. Another one that was special and did very well for us was Medusa. She finished second in the Matchmaker and earned over a million dollars."

It seems you race pretty much all over. Do you have a favorite track?

"I guess that would be The Meadowlands. It is generally referred to as the Mecca of the sport and it is. Together with Mohawk, the Red Mile and Harrah's Hoosier, it is where a significant number of our best and most important races take place."

How about drivers? From the outside looking in it seems that you generally use the best that might be available wherever you are racing.

"To a great degree that is true, but if I were asked to pick just one it would be Tim Tetrick. We get along very well. He is one of the greatest drivers our sport has ever known. Other than Timmy, we usually go with the one who we consider the best available at the time. In today's racing there are very few poor drivers. They are all, to varying degrees, very good. It more often than not comes down to the horse they are sitting behind."

Do you go to the races to watch your horses?

"Probably not near as much as I should. We fans have been spoiled by the easy access to racing at multiple tracks while enjoying the comforts of home. It is especially so in my case where I am almost always racing at more than one track. Basically, all I need do is switch the channel to go to the next horse, the next track and the next race."

Which brings up the question, how do you keep up with them? You might have 10 or up to 30 horses racing at three or four venues on a given night. How do you get to see them all?

"Mark Weaver has developed an app that enables him to keep up with his over 300 horses in the Burke stable. He has generously shared it with me. I rarely am unable to see one of mine race."

How much of a hands-on administrator are you when it comes to managing your horses?

"When it comes to discussions with the trainers, probably significantly, but not overbearingly so. With drivers, hardly at all. We have recently hired Marc Reynolds as a member of our team. He coordinates a great deal finding races for the horses and dealing with the horsemen who take care of them. One of Marc's chief duties, if not the chief one, is keeping on the lookout for available horses to acquire. At one time, our main source was on site auctions. In recent years, these are going the way of the dodo bird. Other than the big one at Harrisburg and a few shrinking ones in Ohio, they have become almost obsolete. Marc constantly watches races and scours the internet looking for horses that might fit our needs. He also has his nose to the ground at the various racetracks and training centers. There aren't a whole lot of people in the business that Marc doesn't know. He more often than not will have entree to horses that might be available. He understands that we place a premium on quality and knows exactly the type of horse we are looking to acquire.

"Another of our perhaps hidden assets are my in-laws. They love the sport and follow our horses as avidly — sometimes more — than I do. If I don't know something about any of our horses, they often do."

What is it that you enjoy the most about the business?

"Primarily the excitement and the competition. I have always been a very competitive person. I just love competition. It encourages me to know more and to become better at just about everything that I do."

Are there things that you dislike or think that can be improved in the business?

"A few, but not that many.

- **"1. Licensing**. As most know, it can be a monumental pain in the rear end. It is improving though.
- **"2. Our purse structure at many, if not most racetracks.** I feel that generally speaking a claimer will go for more money, sometimes significantly more money than an overnight or high-class horse of comparable ability or more, especially a young one. I feel that it places a premium on mediocrity at the expense of horses of more quality.
- **"3.** The fact that some tracks will still race each other at the same time. I understand that significant work is being done to help coordinate these race times. I see improvement, but we are not quite where I would like to see us. Doing so helps everybody.
- **"4. So much day racing.** I still need to have a day job in order to feed the needs of my racing stable. Racing in the daytime does not allow me and probably more owners to enjoy my horses as much as I would like to.
- **"5. The crazy and almost unbelievably low rate that the racetracks get for their signal.** The tracks and the horsemen bear all the work and the expenses involved in putting on the races. All they get is a measly three per cent for their huge investment. That percentage should be double or more than what it is."

What do you see the future in harness racing for yourself being?

"I would love to get bigger and better. The latter more than the former. I see myself as being a very passionate person. There are very few things in life that ignite my passion more than racing does."



Ponda Jet flying high thanks to maturity, equipment changes

In the first three starts of his sophomore campaign, Ponda Jet has shown himself to be a much different trotter than the freshman that lined up behind the gate in 2022. The Dover Dan—Ponda's Lucky Lady gelding has tallied three victories for trainer Jay Hochstetler, the latest an impressive 1:52 effort

Friday night (May 19) in the \$22,000 final of The Expression. Ponda Jet's 2023 form is markedly improved over last season when he was plaqued with breaks.

"He's matured so much this year. I always thought he was the fastest colt, but he could not mentally put it together," said Hochstetler. "He's such a different horse this year. We made some changes, a lot of them we made in the last start last year. We found the ticket to it too late last year, but so far it's been the ticket this year, too. He's got a hell of an engine, I know that."

Maturity is one component to the gelding's newfound success. Equipment changes account for another. Late in the 2022 season, Hochstetler added a homemade cord behind the trotter's bit. It was first implemented in a schooling session with favorable results. The trainer used it in the last start of the season, the \$270,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final, with good results. In that event, driver Kyle Wilfong started from the outside post as the longest shot on the board with triple-digit odds. He ducked Ponda Jet early, then the pair turned in the fastest last quarter of the field to finish fourth.

"He's a completely different animal when that cord is in his mouth. It's unbelievable," Hochstetler said. "Kyle had the nine hole and took him all the way to last. He said, 'I couldn't have even thought of doing that before we put this on."



In January, Hochstetler added an open bridle, and Ponda Jet took to that change as well as the homemade cord. Prior to the changes, the gelding collected a pair of wins at 2, but immaturity produced two likely outcomes each time he lined up behind the gate. The young trotter would either jump it off before the gate folded or soon thereafter, or he would fire straight to the front. In either scenario, Ponda Jet often took himself out of contention. At one point last year he finished out of the money in five of six starts.

"He was just so high strung. He was either trying to run away or he was shutting his air off. He wouldn't let you drive him. You had to leave with him, otherwise he was running behind the gate. Then, you had to go fast because if you grabbed into him too much, he was going to run then too," Hochstetler said. "He was wearing himself out early because he was so out of control. He's not that way this year. He's really developing into a horse that you can rate and control. He's receptive to being told what to do."

Although the trotter struggled to earn checks consistently, Hochstetler credits his father, Homer, for his efforts last year managing and teaching Ponda Jet in a majority of his freshman starts. He was also in the bike this winter at Pinehurst when the gelding began to make improvements.

"He drove him most of last year to try to keep his head on straight, and he's done a lot of the work with him this winter to keep him calm and relaxed on the racetrack," Jay said.

Wilfong was handed the lines late last season and has become Ponda Jet's regular driver. The reinsman and Hochstetler grew up together as their families competed on the Chicago circuit. The trainer enlisted Wilfong to drive his pupil after success with a similarly-difficult horse.

"He actually drove a horse very similar to this horse back in Chicago for us named Anthonyskywalker. He was kind of a lunatic. Really tough to hold in the post parade and behind the gate. That's kind of why we picked Kyle in the first place. He did so good with that horse," Jay said.

The pairing has worked well. After the fourth-place performance to close out 2022, Wilfong and Ponda Jet are perfect in 2023. Sent off as the second choice in the opening leg of The Expression, held May 3, the gelding won by two lengths with a 1:53.1 clocking. In the \$11,000 second leg the two wired the field as the favorites in a time of 1:53.2.

Lining up fourth in a field of seven Friday evening (May 19), Wilfong settled into the pocket behind early leader Just Show Up through a :27.4 opening panel. Moving to the front on the way to the half (:55.4) the duo built a margin of three and one-half lengths. They would go on to win handily by two and one-half lengths and complete the series sweep.

"These are huge. It's really a good time for trial and error. I wanted to see if all the changes we made were going to make

sense in a race," the conditioner said of the value of the early series leading into sires stakes. "If I didn't have a series like this, I'd be going in a qualifier, but it's not the same. We need to make sure he's handy and able to race, and race the way we want him to."

The winning time is significant as it ranks among the fastest this season for sophomore trotters. At the time of writing, only Air Show (1:51) and Walner Payton (1:51.4) have recorded faster winning miles. Owned by a partnership that includes Hochstetler's mother, Connie, Robert Buddig and Allen Schwartz, the Pond-A-Acres-bred trotter is peaking at just the right time with Indiana Sires Stakes slated to begin May 29.

"There's a lot of good colts, so he's going to have to do that about every sires stakes leg," Jay said shortly after the latest victory. "It didn't seem like it was overly taxing for him. He's going to have his plate full. Tonight, there were a couple good ones. In sires stakes, there are nine other good ones along with you."

Jay's charge appears to be on the right trajectory thanks in part to equipment changes and time to mature. The sky, as they say, is the limit.

PONDA WARRIOR ON THE MEND

While Ponda Jet is off to a fast start, the 4-year-old debut of ISS Super Final winner and Breeders Crown starter Ponda Warrior is delayed. Jay said the goal was to compete in the Graduate Series with the pacer, but a chip was found in his front ankle after qualifying at Pinehurst in April.

"I'm very fortunate to have a wife that is a vet. I told her to x-ray him head to toe before we started racing. He didn't show me any signs of it, but we found it on an x-ray. The surgery went incredibly well. If all things go well, he should be back August 1," Jay said.

Owned by Jay Hochstetler, Finkelberg Racing LLC and South Of The Tracks Rac Inc, Ponda Warrior underwent surgery to remove the chip a little over two weeks ago. The son of Rockin Image—Sweetnsinful won six times last season, banking \$360,275 of the \$476,475 on his card. While disappointed his pacing star is sidelined, the trainer believes the extended rest may play to his advantage as the year wears on.

"It might work out for the best," Jay said. "For one, we rectified a problem that we didn't really know was there. And two, he's not going to gut himself early on and maybe we'll have the freshest legs when the big money is on the line at the end."





Camluck Classic crossover

Mohawk stars prominent in the premier stakes race at The Raceway at The Western Fair District.

Canada's two most successful current harness tracks by handle are Woodbine Mohawk Park and The Raceway at The Western Fair District. Next Friday (May 26), top older pacers converge at the latter for the \$150,000 Camluck Classic Invitational. Two of them are coming in after May victories at seven-eighths-mile Mohawk, a track that clearly plays to different strengths.

American History (p,3,1:47m; \$1,494,205) won the May 13 WMP preferred-2 in a sizzling 1:48.2 seasonal best, currently

the fastest Canadian mile of 2023. His half-mile track record is 1:49.3, set when he captured the 2019 Bobby Quillen Memorial at Harrington Raceway for previous connections.

Now owned by Brad Grant of Milton, ON and trained by Richard Moreau, the 8-year-old stallion has been racing exclusively at Mohawk since June 4, 2022, when he won his first start after the 2022 Camluck Classic. Starting from The Raceway's outside post position on May 27, American History and driver Travis Cullen trailed throughout the 1:50.2 edition, won by Jimmy Freight.

The American Ideal — Perfect Touch son's Mohawk debut was in an elimination for the 2018 North America Cup, in which the former Tony Alagna trainee finished third as the beaten favorite. In line to Yannick Gingras for the final, American History was parked throughout and finished last behind 1:48.1 winner Lather Up.

He found redemption in the 2019 Breeders Crown open pace at Mohawk. Sent to the opening quarter in :25.4 by catch driver Joe Bongiorno, American History surrendered his early lead to Dorsoduro Hanover past the half. The 4-year-old came on again down the stretch, taking the inside path to a 1:48.3 victory.

So far this season, American History has four wins at Mohawk. At publication deadline, he was slated to take on seven other free-for-allers in Mohawk's Saturday night (May 20) top class. Driver Trevor Henry was aboard for the pacer's Canadian seasonal record last Saturday and is driving him for just the second time this Saturday.

Other confirmed 2023 Camluck Classic entrants include **Whichwaytothebeach** (p, 3, 1:49.2s; \$647,445), who began his 2023 campaign with a 1:50.1 WMP victory on May 8, for driver



James MacDonald and trainer Desiree Jones. The 5-year-old Somebeachsomewhere—Swinging Beauty gelding is owned by Gino Toscani of Mount Hope, ON, and will be stepping up in class at Mohawk Saturday night (May 20). The Camluck Classic will be his first start at The Raceway at Western Fair. His record on a half is a front-end 1:52.4 victory in a leg of the 2022 Borgata Series at Yonkers Raceway.

Three horses who have been recently active at Yonkers will be taking on the two Mohawk-based pacers in the 2023 Camluck Classic:

Reigning half-mile track World Champion **This Is The Plan** (p, 6, 1:47.3h; \$3,038,197) had a tough trip in the 2022 Camluck Classic, starting from The Raceway's trailing post and finishing second-last for driver Trevor Henry.

The 2022 MGM Borgata Pacing Series champion **Funatthebeach N** (p, 8, 1:49.2h; \$1,062,487) finished third in a May 14, 2022 WMP preferred before his fourth-place finish for driver Jordan Stratton in the 2022 Camluck Classic.

Covered Bridge (p, 4, 1:48.3m; \$827,250) is making his first appearance at the London, ON half-mile. He captured two legs of the 2023 MGM Borgata Series and was third as beaten favorite in the final. The gelding is undefeated in the Yonkers open handicap this month, in two starts from outside posts.

Idealsomemagic A (p,9,1:51.2h; \$283,317) arrived in the U.S. from Australia late last year, making just one North American start. The Cory Stratton trainee has since racked up eight 2023 victories at Yonkers, including three legs of the MGM Borgata Series.

Newcomer **Mac's Big Boy** (p, 5, 1:48.4s; \$435,346) was confirmed on Friday (May 19), as the track has released the names of participating pacers in a staggered fashion over the past week. The gelding has two wins this year, most recently in Hoosier Park's open 1-2 on May 5.

With seven confirmed starters and the draw coming up on Monday (May 22), The Raceway at Western Fair has not confirmed a possible eighth starter in the Camluck Classic. Speculation has swirled about who that pacer, rumored to be a WMP regular, might be. The name was unconfirmed at deadline.

The 40th annual Pepsi North America Cup is scheduled for Saturday, June 17 at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Tickets went on sale on Saturday (May 19). Each \$10 general admission ticket is redeemable as a \$10 betting voucher for the North America Cup live card. Advance tickets can only be purchased at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Admission for youth (17 years of age and younger) remains free.

My biggest score

You may notice this report does not have a byline. There is a reason for anonymity. In 1995, at age 25, I was the mastermind of a criminal gang, a diverse crew of five racetrack aficionados.

We were a mixed bag of racing nuts. We each had a nickname for a preferred method of wagering on harness horse races. Mark, a plumber, was known as "Showtime" because he only wagered to show. Larry, "The Exactor Raptor" worked on the Chevy plant assembly line. Ronnie, a retired mailman, was dubbed "Late Delivery" because he waited to see the last flash of the tote board before plunking down his wager. Otto, one of the first computer repairmen, was a hunch player we named "Plates" because he jotted down the license number of the last vehicle parked in row C and used the numbers in his wagering.

We met at the harness racetrack and somehow morphed into a band of brothers. At five o'clock every Friday night, we gathered at the McDonald's in front of the Bellville Shopping Mall. I arrived in my 1985 Dodge Van, the wheelman for a carefully orchestrated caper.

I worked out of the backroom of my uncle Phil's printing company, Quick Print Inc, a brick box of a building in the industrial parkway. My specialties were business cards, wedding invitations and napping in a folding chair near the coffee machine.

Our scam began at lunchtime each Friday when I drove to the Rexall Drugstore, purchased a copy of the Friday night harness race program and returned to the print shop. Using company equipment, I reproduced four copies of the race program for the crew. Each member already had their clubhouse pass that I artfully forged and laminated.

We gathered a table in the kids' playroom of McDonald's. There were rarely any children diving into the giant net cage filled with colorful balls, possibly due to the five animated men sitting close by and waving their arms. I distributed the programs and we got to work eating fast food, chatting about world affairs, gossiping and handicapping. At a quarter to six, we all hopped into my van and I chauffeured the crew a mile to the harness racetrack and paid the \$2 parking fee.

In 1995, racetracks still charged customers for parking, programs and entrance. Due to my plagiarized race programs, forged documents for entry, car-pooling and clogging up the McDonald's parking lot, each crew member saved six bucks. Six dollars may not seem like a lot of money, but none of the crew had much money. I still lived in my mother's basement, the air conditioner in my van had died years ago and my muffler dangled from a twisted coat hanger.

As we settled into our grandstand seats every Friday, every single Friday, Ronnie chirped, "This is a sweet deal. Three races on house money."

The statute of limitations allows me to describe my print shop misadventures, but this is all just background to the evening of May 5, 1995.

My wager was always the same, a five-race parlay. Therefore, my nickname was "Sir Parlance-a-lot." When, or if, I won a race, I let all the winning money ride, bet all my winnings on the next race and repeated the process. The night of the big score began innocently when my wager of \$2 on a 3-1 shot got home in a photo finish in the first race. My payoff was \$8. I cashed the ticket and while still at the window, I placed all the money on a 5-1 shot, a trotter, that won the second race easily.

I will not bore you with a play-by-play or a significant buildup. I won the first four races. The crew began to pay close attention when I wagered \$190 on the fourth race, my largest wager of all time by \$120. Soon, my blue and yellow Hawaiian shirt pocket bulged with \$1,840. My heart rate was in the same range.

Everyone knew I preselected one horse in each race because I circled my choices and drew stars around the circles. I often bragged about these selections. My choice in the fifth race was a long shot, a very long shot. The number five had a circle and stars resembling a giant eyeball staring back at the crew and me. On the tote board, the five, a pacing filly, was 22-1.

I stuttered when I asked our resident mathematic whiz, Plates, "Wha, what, what would the payout be if I bet it all on the five?"

He trembled, thought for about 30 seconds, and croaked, "A lot."

"That much?" I asked.

"Well, if you wager all that money in your pocket, the odds will go down."

"Ballpark me," I whispered.

"Fifteen, 20 grand."

Showtime moaned, "I might pee my pants. Seriously, I can't take this."

Late Delivery held his hands on his head, walking in small circles, muttering.

Where is the dividing line between excitement and terror? My mind was a kaleidoscope of adrenaline, testosterone, calculations and fear. The clock was ticking. Visions of a new I will not bore you with a play-by-play or a significant buildup. I won the first four races. van, cocktails on the sands of Aruba, or buying a yearling all danced in my head. The crew was as rattled as I was. Someone would start to say something and stop as if they did not want to have fingerprints on the looming decision.

When the announcer boomed, "Two minutes, two minutes to post." Eyes darted nervously. I turned and headed for the \$50 betting window and my crew followed like a funeral procession. The \$50 window was open, so any thoughts of being shut out as an excuse vanished. I still did not know what words would come out of my mouth when I got to the teller.

I placed my wager. The clerk looked at me and raised an eyebrow. I handed him the money; he punched the tickets.

The crew silently headed toward the grandstand. I walked to the parking lot in a daze.

Seven minutes later, the slapping of palms on the van windows and smiles told me the results. I got out of the van to a handshaking and back-slapping flurry.

Late Delivery asked the question. "Did you bet it all?"

After a pregnant pause, I shook my head no.

The crew remained silent.

"I bet \$55 to win, \$55 to place and \$55 to show."

Nothing but silence hung in the air as we all did the math in our heads. There were a lot of variables, taxes and the odds fluctuated just before the machines locked. When the dust settled, my winnings were slightly over \$3,500, the most money I ever won at the racetrack, my personal best.

An hour later, we sat in my van, relaxed, like soldiers smoking cigarettes in the trenches, discussing the last battle. We began to rationalize.

The Raptor said, "The long odds is what screwed things up. The five did not look like a good play. Think of it like this, if you had picked the chalk and wagered the whole \$1,800 on the chalk, you would be about where you are, financially."

Late Delivery said, "Yeah, the 20 grand thoughts were illusionary or delusionary. They mess with the normal thought patterns of human beings. It's hard to think straight with that much money on the line."

Plates took a philosophical viewpoint, "Three grand, 20 grand, in the grand scheme of things, what's the difference?"

I turned the ignition key and pulled forward when we heard a thump, scraping and a tremendous roar through the open windows as my muffler fell off.

Showtime shouted over the roar, "And you can afford to fix that tomorrow."

Good or bad day. What do you say?

When Rick and Theresa Ledford would visit Balmoral Park, Maywood Park, Hawthorne Racecourse and Sportsman's Park in Chicago, their young daughter, Desirae, would gladly accompany them. They made it a family affair and it remains that way today.

Rick Ledford was a top harness driver back in the 1980s until he was injured in a horse racing accident. That was enough for the family man to reconsider and decide to stick to training for the sake of his family.

"Growing up I was always at the barn in the morning or going to the track to hang out with all of my favorite people," Desirae said. "As a kid I was convinced that someday I was going to marry top horseman Tony Alagna.

"Every day I would bring Tony a peanut butter and jelly sandwich for we were stabled next to each other in Barn 26. I was so infatuated with Alagna that I even gave him a puppy from my dog's litter.

During the summers of junior high and high school, Desirae became involved playing softball where she got a full ride to college to play softball.

"Although this was a great time in my life, I had to leave the horses for a while, but once you're bitten by the horse bug... it never leaves your heart and soul.

"Well, I didn't marry Tony Alagna when I grew up, but I met my husband and father of our two daughters thereafter."

It was actually social media that brought Desirae and her future husband together.

"Travis, my husband of 11 years and I met, believe it or not, on Facebook," Desirae said. "He posted a status saying, 'Like this post and I'll tell you something I like about you.'

"I liked it and he responded, 'I like your name and that you live in Chicago.' That Wednesday Travis had to come to Balmoral Park to qualify a horse so I baked him a batch of my famous brownies. I brought them to the track and to this day I'm not sure if he ate them, or everyone else in the paddock did, but they were all gone. That weekend Travis came back and we've basically lived together ever since."

Travis' parents, Joe and Tina Seekman, are also involved in harness racing — his father at one time was a top trainer — so it was no surprise when their son followed in their footsteps.

"Today, Travis and I run a small stable at the family farm in Gaston, IN, where we train six standardbreds," Desirae said. "I also have my broodmare at home, along with several turnouts and the family pony Bonnie.

"My favorite horse — although I love each and every one of them — it would be Rockin Speed and the fastest horse I've trained is Major Attitude. He went in 1:50.3 at Hoosier Park and he's been a great asset to our small stable."

Travis, 32, recently went over \$1 million in purse money, with 102 winning drives in a shortened racing season.

"It was certainly a proud wife moment and I'm so glad all the hard work is starting to show," Desirae said.

As the saying goes first comes love, then comes marriage and then comes the baby in a baby carriage. Well, make that two.

After Desirae gave birth to two daughters, Raegyn and Graecyn, she still managed to help in the barn with the horses.

"I have to admit that it was a lot easier with just Raegyn, but after Graecyn was born, it definitely was more difficult," Desirae said.

Besides being a wife, mother and horsewoman, Desirae runs a small business called Design by Des.

"I make a lot of custom gear for the horsemen and ship the products all over the United States. I've even shipped custom gear to Canada, Switzerland and Australia," she said. "It's really cool watching races from The Meadowlands — all the way to Cal Expo — and seeing you being represented.

"People keep asking me, 'How do you do it all?' and 'When do you sleep?' I answer, 'I just do it.' After all, I don't have an option not to. My family comes first and I want my children to see that hard work pays off."

Luckily for the Seekmans, their two daughters also love horses.

"Raegyn, my oldest, adores them," Desirae said. "She loves going to the barn and getting dirty in her princess dresses. She helps clean stalls, tries to fill the buckets and once in a while jogs with daddy.

"My youngest, Graecyn, is only 14 months so right now she doesn't do much other than yell doggy when we walk in the barn [She can't say horsey yet]. And she is good at eating the horse grain, too. Typical barn kid stuff."

The Seekmans currently race at Hoosier Park in Indiana, but occasionally go to Ohio to race at Dayton or Miami Valley.

As far as sitting behind one of her horses in a race, well that will have to wait.

"I have driven at a few fairs in the past, but now that I'm a mom I am putting my time and energy into the breeding business more," Desirae said. "I love working with my husband and think we make a great team. We implement feedback off of one another pretty well and feel blessed to be doing what I love while raising a family."

David Miller brings home career winner 14,000

Hall Of Fame driver David Miller posted the 14,000th victory of his career on Friday afternoon (May 19) at Harrah's Philadelphia when he guided **Island Of The Sea** to victory. It was not an easy journey for the Always A Virgin gelding, parked past a :26.1 quarter to get the lead then going on to hang up numbers of :54.2 and 1:22 before pacing on to a 1:50 win for trainer Eric Ell, co-owner with Lisa Ell.



Miller, 58, recorded his 14,000th victory in career start 69,240, reflecting a lifetime win percentage over 20 per cent. He is the sixth North American driver to reach the 14,000 figure and sits fourth among active drivers: preceding him, listed in current order of lifetime victories, were Dave Palone, Tony Morgan, Herve Filion, Cat Manzi, and Aaron Merriman. Miller is also the leading active driver in terms of his horses' career earnings at \$272.5 million and trails only John Campbell's all-time mark of \$299.9 million.

Christchurch delivers at Big M

Trainer Nancy Takter had some serious expectations for her 3-year-old colt **Christchurch** at The Meadowlands Friday night (May 19) and in the aftermath of his performance in the non-winners of two, he marked himself as a big-time player in the July 15 Meadowlands Pace.

"If that horse keeps his mind right," Takter said Thursday morning. "There isn't a single [3-year-old] in the country who can beat him."

And the son of Always B Miki—Darlinonthebeach made his trainer look good.

Christchurch put on an awesome display of power in his first start of the year after a pair of eye-popping qualifiers, drubbing five overmatched foes in 1:49.3, the second fastest mile of 2023 put up by a 3-year-old male pacer.

"He's a big, strong horse," Takter said after the win. "I knew he had it in him, it's just going to be about managing him and getting him more controllable."

On Friday night, he looked like a horse who was in control every step of the way.

Driver Dexter Dunn had Christchurch away quickly at the start and was on the lead around the first turn before hitting the quarter in :27.1. Caviart Scotland, Takter's other starter in the race, couldn't find a spot and had to go after the leader to the half, grabbing the lead at the midpoint in a taxing :54.2.

Looking stubborn and unwilling to sit a two-hole trip, Christchurch was up and after the leader shortly thereafter and sprinted back to the top while opening up a 2¼-length edge at three-quarters in 1:22.2. From there, Christchurch strode to the wire a much-the-best winner after displaying a final quarter of :27.1 to hit the finish 2¼ lengths in front of Dupree Hanover. Hungry Angel Boy was third.

"He's got all the tools in the world to be something special," Takter said. "He's got the gait and has a great set of lungs and his heart rate is probably the lowest of any horse I've ever trained. If we can just get him to relax a little bit, I think he's going to be really good. We're pointing him to the [June 17] North America Cup so we're going to try and find one more race before then and then it's off to Canada. I think as the year goes on, he'll probably settle down a little bit and find himself and, hopefully, he will shine."

As the 3-5 favorite, Christchurch, who's won three-of-eight lifetime starts, returned \$3.40 to his backers.

A LITTLE MORE: After three straight second-place finishes, **Jody** got up on the wire to take the \$17,000 overnight feature for pacing mares in 1:51.1. Driven by Yannick Gingras and trained by Ron Burke, the 5-year-old daughter of

Betterthancheddar—Topgun Lady returned \$4.40 as the 6-5 public choice. Scott Zeron led the driver colony with three winners. All-source handle on the 13-race card was \$2,746,857.

Raised By Lindy (Yannick Gingras) was a willing second, closing up from fourth while trotting home in :26.2 in her first qualifier.
