Propulsion vs. Readly Express and Aubrion du Gers in today's Elitlopp

Propulsion's Daniel Redén is the first trainer to have four horses in the Swedish classic since it began in 1952.

So what's the big deal this year? Solvalla has described today's edition pretty much as a battle between Readly Express and Propulsion, but there are 14 other horses that can win the contest.

Readly Express will be the first choice in the first elimination and it's highly likely that Timo Nurmos' horse will solve the task he has ahead of him, where post seven seems to be the biggest issue for him.

Trainer Daniel Redén has managed to get four trotters in the 2019 Elitlopp — the first time a trainer has landed that many horses in the Swedish classic — and Double Exposure and Sorbet will both try to get a spot in the final in the same heat as Readly Express.

"I'm satisfied with them both. Double Exposure's last month has been just something extra and I've said to other media that I've never in my career felt a horse in better condition than her. With that said, I'm excited to see what she can do among colts and geldings over the mile, because I know she's tough. Sorbet draw bad post position and he'll just seek a cover trip and try to reach the final, if he's lucky," Redén said.

The trainer has Propulsion and Heavy Sound in the second elimination.

Propulsion will contest the Elitloppet for the fourth year in a row, while Heavy Sound is new in the Elitlopp; so as his driver Kenneth Haugstad.

"Propulsion is where I want him to be right now.

Olympiatravet was a tough one for him, but with this horse,

I'm confident and I know that he's in perfect shape for the moment. Heavy Sound has many skills that are valuable in a mile race like Elitloppet. His technique in the turns, his speed and his condition are all factors that will be important," said Redén.

Jean-Michel Bazire-trained Aubrion du Gers, driven by Jos Verbeeck, will probably be the first choice in the second heat and the mystique that surrounds him is the question whether he can leave fast enough to get the lead or not from post one behind the gate. It's said that the French trotter will race in an American bike for the first time in this heat and with a closed bridle, Verbeeck can surely send Aubrion du Gers quickly the first 150 meters.

The purse of \$620,000 is at stake in the final heat of Elitloppet that is scheduled to go behind the gate at 5:20 p.m. (CET – 11:20 a.m. New York time). The first Elitloppet elimination is scheduled for 2.55 p.m., CET (8:55 a.m. New York time) and the second elimination is set for 3.22 p.m., CET (9:22 a.m. New York time).

Impossible winner in Sweden Cup

Three eliminations which led to a final where nine trotters fought for \$125,000. That was the condition when the Sweden Cup was held Saturday at Solvalla, the day before today's Elitlopp.

Cyber Lane (Raja Mirchi) was the first choice in the first elimination and Johan Untersteiner had no problem sending his horse to the lead from post one. Cyber Lane took a wire to wire win in a moderate 1:54 mile.

Dante Boko (Going Kronos) and Adrian Kolgjini won the second heat after a cover trip, while Finnish-bred Lexus Dream (Lexus Font) lead every meter in the third race for Ari Moilanen.

Nine horses gathered around the track of Solvalla in the final and the race became considerably more spectacular than the eliminations.

Cyber Lane opened quickly from post three and got Chief Orlando on the outside while the pace was set to a mile rate of 1:51.3 the first half mile.

Chief Orlando seemed to get an advantage in the end of the last turn and driver Björn Goop had control of leader Cyber Lane in mid home stretch. But from out of nowhere, Queer Fish (Varenne) showed up far outside after a trip in fourth on the inside. With 300 meters to go, it looked like Queer Fish could reach a smaller piece of the price money. At that point, driver Ulf Eriksson still hadn't free space to use with his horse.

And Queer Fish flew in the home stretch, he flew fast enough to disarm Chief Orlando by a head and fresh trainer Magnus Träff celebrated his biggest success at the tracks.

"We put Queer Fish in the race most for fun and we got a bad number in the elimination, so we made this trip and just wanted to enjoy the day. And now we're here. It's just unbelievable", said Träff in the winner's circle after the prestigious win in 1:52.1.

Finland wins Harper Hanover's Race and hockey berth

As Finland's Ollie Koivonen turned into the home stretch with his Eelis, the Finnish national hockey team made history by beating Russia to qualify for the world championship final against Canada.

The \$180,000 Harper Hanover's Race, over approximately 1.95 miles, is one of the top races during the Elitlopp weekend at Solvalla and, as usual, the contest was an attraction for the spectators in Stockholm.

With 15 horses starting from three different distances, Timo Nurmos-trained Magic Cash hit the lead at an early stage and driver Jorma Kontio really had great trust in his horse. Kontio set too fast the pace for a three-lap race and Magic Cash was a beaten horse with a half-mile to go.

But Timo Nurmos could celebrate anyway since his Eelis (Enjoy Lavec) finished strongly after a cover trip for Koivonen.

The mile rate of 1:57.3 is just extraordinary for a horse with just lifetime earnings of approximately \$70,000 before the race and Finland as a country experienced some happy minutes right at this moment.

New record at auction on Friday night

The Elitauktion in Stockholm the days before the Elitlopp set a new record regarding the price for a yearling at this particular sale in Sweden. Top trainer Lutfi Kolgjini paid 1,525,000 Swedish crowns (\$159,000) for Bottnas Ideal (Ready Cash—Aisle Stand). Aisle Stand was a star trotter herself in Stefan Melander's stable and she won, among other races, the Breeders Crown for 3-year-olds and the Solvalla Grand Prix.

Finnish driver tops after four races in WDC

The World Driving Championship started at Solvalla racetrack on Friday afternoon and Canadian title holder James MacDonald won one of the three races during the first day.

But it's Finnish driver Mika Forss that has collected most points after two days and four races at Solvalla. Forss won the first race on Friday's race card, MacDonald the second and Sweden's Ulf Ohlsson the third.

One race was on the card on Saturday afternoon and Dutch driver Rick Ebbinge took a safe wire to wire win, which puts him among the five drivers in the top before the competition resume on Monday.

Elitlopp makes world premier today on Twitch

A huge crowd was at Solvalla on Saturday. Those that can't make it to the track today for the Elitlopp card can watch and comment on the races via Twitch.

Today, millions of trotting fans around the world are watching Sweden as the Elitloppet takes place in Stockholm. Some 50,000 fans are expected to attend the event at Solvalla and millions more will be watching the races from home. To involve the audience and engage them in the experience, the Swedish betting company ATG is letting fans comment live on the races on the streaming platform Twitch. It will mark the first time trotting is streamed on Twitch.

"We want to involve our fans during their biggest sports event and it feels like we have found a new opportunity to do this in an engaging way. We capture the atmosphere among the fans and share it with others. At Twitch it is easy for the viewers to interact with the commentators," said Sten Andersen, chief marketing and PR officer at ATG.

Altogether, 24 races will be broadcasted and commented live on Twitch, at the channel 1337-race (channel link here). During six hours Sunday, various guests are invited to a commentators booth at the actual sports event. One of them is the Swedish gaming streamer Tejbz with hundreds of thousands followers on Twitch. He is also hosting the broadcast on Sunday.

Streaming service Twitch allow viewers to watch their favorite gamers in real time, and this is typically how popular gamers have built up their fandoms. Now Swedish betting company ATG is turning its head to Twitch for inspiration as they will let their audience live comment the biggest trotting event of the year, the Elitloppet.

Make it three Halls of Fame for **Jimmy Takter**

Swedish native Jimmy Takter will be inducted into the Travets Storheter in the Nordic Trot Museum less than a month before the trainer is inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame.

U.S. Hall of Famer Jimmy Takter will Racing Hall of Fame in soon be the toast of the sport's Halls of Fame in Canada and his native Sweden, as well.

Swedish native Jimmy Takter said he was deeply honored to learn that on July 13 he will be inducted into the Hall of Fame at the Nordic Trot Museum. The announcement was made this week as part of the pre-Elitlopp celebrations in Stockholm.

His enshrinement comes less than a month before he is inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame. Takter, who was inducted Claus Andersen into the (U.S.) Harness 2012 is the first person in harness racing history to be inducted into three

Halls of Fame exclusive to the sport.

"I am extremely proud to be the first one to be inducted into Hall in three countries," Takter said. "That's tough to beat."

Takter will be inducted to the Travets Storheter — located at the Nordic museum in Värmland, Sweden – with Jorma Kontio, Roger Walmann and 2001 Hambletonian winner Scarlet Knight.

Inductees are chosen by the Swedish Horse Sports Journalists' Club (SHK) and the Norwegian Trotting Journalists' Club (NTJK).

Takter retired in December of 2018. He is credited with 9,972 starts, 2,157 wins and earnings of \$130,132,900. The eight years between 1983, when he started training, and 1991, when they started keeping trainer records, are not accounted for. As a driver, he has won 824 of 4,370 starts and posted earnings of \$24,447,651 in 35 years in the sulky.

HRU European correspondent Thomas Hedlund explains why Sweden's V75 bet has been the key to harness racing's survival in his country.

The V75: The lifeblood of Swedish harness racing

National exposure and the possibility of a life-changing score while betting on horses has made the V75 lottery wager a boon to Sweden's trotting industry — and there's not a casino or slot machine in sight.

HRU's European correspondent Thomas Hedlund said Sweden's V75 bet is the single biggest reason harness racing has been thriving in his country since the jackpot-style wager was launched more than 25 years ago.

"Since (Swedish betting regulator) ATG started (the V75) in 1993, the whole sport got an injection of interest – in the horses, and trainers and drivers. In addition to that, people could bet small money and win much money," Hedlund said.

Unlike North American operations, Swedish harness tracks do not have casinos or slot machines to sustain them. Hedlund said they rely on the V75, a popular national bet that requires punters to pick the winners of seven specially-selected races on a card.

"There are 9 million people in Sweden and during the year 2 million people bet on V75," Hedlund said of the wager that

people can make online, on their phones, at kiosks in grocery stores and at some gas stations.

As U.S.-born, Swedish-based trainer Jerry Riordan said, making the V75 available in family-friend areas such as grocery stores and gas stations — as opposed to bars that operate betting shops in France — creates great acceptance and exposure for the sport throughout Sweden at a young age. Harness racing is, surprisingly, a younger person's game in Sweden compared to North America.

Even more exposure for the sport is achieved through live broadcasts of all V75 races on a Swedish national TV channel.

What's most appealing about the bet is the potential for large jackpots. The payout record for the V75 is a life-changing 67.3 million Swedish Crowns (approximately \$6.73 million U.S. dollars).

Riordan said, few people know someone that has won the lottery, but most people know someone who has hit the V75.

Hedlund can attest. His personal best is hitting the V75 for about \$89,000 (U.S.).

"We were 15 people sharing, so it was great. It was the summer of 2013. I composed the (ticket) and I was a wreck

after the sixth race, because I only had two horses in the last race and one of them made a break early and disappeared from the race. The other one won and we got 892,000 Swedish Crowns, which is approximately \$90,000. It was a great, great summer night," Hedlund said.

Asked how he celebrated, Hedlund laughed.

"I think I bought a new vacuum cleaner," he said.

On Saturday, Hedlund explained how the V75 works while crafting a ticket in which he successfully picked four of the seven winners.

The V75 is usually offered once a week, normally on a Saturday — the exception being Elitlopp weekend when it is offered both on Saturday and Sunday. The track for the V75 races changes from week to week. Unlike North American races which are almost always contested at a mile, the V75 races offer different distances and starting methods to enhance the handicapping challenge. On Saturday, the last leg of the V75 was a race that was nearly two miles in length requiring three trips around the Solvalla oval.

Saturday's V75 at Solvalla paid approximately 10,000,000 Swedish Crowns (around \$1 million U.S.)

"One week, you could win maybe \$300 dollars if you pick all seven. Next week, you could win \$1 million, depends on what horse wins, obviously, but this is the charm about this game," Hedlund said.

The ATG also offers a V65, which requires bettors to pick the winners of six races, a V5, which requires bettors to pick the winners of five races, and so on. But the V75 is king in Sweden.

Think of it as a lottery asking people to handicap races rather than pick numbers. Instead of watching bouncing ping pong balls get selected out of a hopper, people watch horses race.

"You've got living creatures, animals and people. In Sweden, agriculture is so important. We don't just have Stockholm, there are lots of small villages around this quite long country with lots of agricultural issues. The horse business, even if it's riding horses, harness horses, gallop horses, it's so important. I think just in the harness business, it's 30,000 or 40,000 people involved," Hedlund said. "We are 9 million people living in Sweden and 40,000 of them are in some way directly involved in harness racing business —

working with horses, food for the horses, transport... so (the V75) is an important thing that this keeps going."

It not only creates great exposure for the sport nationwide on a lottery distribution system, "this is money that the track owners get back," Hedlund said.

He said sometimes horse owners are as excited to win a V75 race as a major stake.

"For the owners, it's a thrill to win V75. They are so happy. You'll see it today, I promise you," Hedlund said.

As to why other countries don't follow Sweden's lead and adopt the V75, Hedlund shook his head.

"I don't know. I really don't know. They should see and learn," Hedlund said.

Bettor's Wish wins 29th Art Rooney Pace

As a yearling, Bettor's Wish sold for all of \$20,000.

"But he's not a \$20,000 horse anymore."

So said co-owner and trainer Chris Ryder Saturday night (May 25) after his charge — and driver Dexter Dunn — made short work of Yonkers Raceway's \$300,000 Art Rooney Pace. It was Kiwis on Parade during a cool and windy Westchester, NY evening.

The 29th Rooney, for 3-year-old colts and geldings (actually, it's an open event, but why quibble?), turned into a romp for the odds-on (\$3.70) choice.

One of the last week's two elimination winners, Bettor's Wish drew post position No. 6 in the finale. He found himself three-wide early, outside of Captain Malicious (Mark MacDonald) and Buddy Hill (Brian Sears) and inside of Blood Money (Scott Zeron).

Blood Money made the lead before a 27-second opening quarter-mile, then a :55.4 intermission. Going down the backside the second time, Rollwithpapajoe (Joe Bongiorno) was advancing out of fifth before he broke stride.

That allowed Buddy Hill a path out of third, and he was about to leave the cones, Bettor's Wish extricated himself from the pocket. He disposed of Blood Money soon after a 1:24.1 three-quarters, preparing to bust the race wide open.

Bettor's Wish slapped three lengths on his rivals in and out of the final turn, then ran it up. The final margin was a half-dozen lengths in a season's-best 1:51.4. Second went to Branquinho (Tyler Buter), while Air Force Hanover (Dave Miller) was third. That tandem offered solid closes, especially 'Air Force', the faster (1:52.4) elim winner who was stuck behind the eight-ball here.

Buddy Hill and Blood Money picked off the remainder, while Captain Malicious — uncoupled stablemate of the runner-up — Price Hanover (Dan Dube) and misbehaving Rollwithpapajoe completed the order.

Bettor's Wish, a Bettor's Delight—Lifetime Star colt also co-owned by Bella Racing, Fair Island Farm and Kenneth Solomon, has won all three of his seasonal starts (\$180,000). The exacta paid \$24, the triple returned \$242.50 and the superfecta paid \$1,138.

"I thought if I stayed in here I could get stuck in a two-hole trip," Dunn said. "It was pretty intense going in the first turn. We'd done a bit of work, but he travelled really good past the half. I decided to pop (before the three-quarters). It could've been a bad move, but the horse pulled through."

"When I first qualified him, I thought he was a very good horse," Ryder said. "I drove him and he won the race, but broke a hopple.

"I knew tonight was a real test. He didn't have the best of posts, but I figured if he's the best he'll get there one way or the other. I'm very thankful of the way Dexter drove him.

"This wasn't an easy race for a driver and he did a great job."

Ryder said Bettor's Wish is off to the Pepsi North America Cup at Woodbine Mohawk Park. For his part, Dunn finished off a helluva week, which began by winning last Sunday's (May 19) Confederation Cup at Flamboro Downs with Done Well.

Saturday night's pair of \$44,000 open Handicaps were won by:

- Trot Weslynn Dancer (Zeron, \$5.80) in 1:54.4.
- Pace Micky Gee N (Jordan Stratton, \$3.80) in 1:52.2.

Bestseller Hanover wins 15th Lismore

Bestseller Hanover (Jason Bartlett, \$14.20) finished what she started Saturday night (May 25), winning Yonkers Raceway's \$109,234 Lismore for 3-year-old pacing fillies.

From position No. 5, she led through intervals of :28.2,:58, 1:25.3 and 1:54.4, choosing a correct evening for her first seasonal victory. En route, she hooked 1-10 favorite Queen of the Pride (Jordan Stratton), before that one made a filthy break in the final turn.

As Time Goes By (George Brennan) was second at 41-1, with Rockn' Philly (Tim Tetrick) third. Annie Hill (Brian Sears) and Mi Nina Bonita (Brent Holland) came away with the minors, while Privacy Hanover (Dave Miller) — uncoupled stablemate of the winner — Rock N McRoll (Dan Dube) and the dance-of-the-danmed Queen of the Pride rounded out the order.

For second choice Bestseller Hanover, a \$130,000 daughter of Somebeachsomewhere—Bittorsweet Terror owned by Millar Farms and trained by Scott Blackler, it was that first win in three 2019 tries. The exacta paid \$198.50, the triple returned \$705 and the superfecta paid \$4,333.

Potential bridge jumpers were spared with no show wagering.

"I raced against Queen of the Pride the last two weeks and noticed Jordan (Stratton) had to hold her together to get her over the turns," Bartlett said. "That's kind of the reason I left.

"I said, 'Well, if he wants to go out of there fast, we will go fast and see what happens in the first turn."

"I didn't realize she was that quick off the gate. I scored her down, spoke to her a little bit, and she was right there on her toes. If I took back, they're going to go to the half slow, we're going to be in a bad spot, so we took our shot."

Bestseller Hanover was a first-up second to Queen of the Pride in their elimination race a week ago.

As for Queen of the Pride, who was wide early before settling fourth, "She threw a shoe coming by the stands and started running in on the turns," Stratton said. "She wasn't getting over the track."

Yonkers now takes a hiatus until Friday night, June 7th.

Lather Up cruises to 1:49 preferred score

Lather Up returned to the scene of his biggest victory to win Saturday's (May 25) \$34,000 preferred in 1:49 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The 2018 Pepsi North America Cup champion headlined a field of seven for the top-class event and was sent off as the 2-5 favourite with Jody Jamieson steering for the first-time.

Physicallyinclined took the early battle to seize the lead and post solid opening fractions of :26 and :53.4. Lather Up and Jamieson angled out from fourth at the half and came first-up on the far turn to lead by a neck at three-quarters in 1:21.4.

Lather Up stormed home effortlessly in :27.1 to win by just under five-lengths in 1:49 with the ear plugs still in. Go West Go Fast finished second, while Traceur Hanover was third and Physicallyinclined fourth.

A 4-year-old son of Im Gorgeous, Lather Up provided his connections with a strong bounce-back performance after failing to make the final of the Confederation Cup in his most recent start. The Clyde Francis trainee now has two victories and \$40,250 earned in three starts this season.

Lather Up is a homebred for Gary and Barbara Iles and now sports career numbers of 17 wins and \$1.1 million earned. The Francis trainee is now expected to compete in next Saturday's Graduate Series leg at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Live racing resumes Monday evening at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Post time is 7:10 p.m.

Captain Callahan wins four at the Big M

All salute!

Saturday night at the Meadowlands belonged to Corey Callahan – aka 'The Captain' – as he drove four winners on the 13-race card.

Callahan's big night began in Race 5 with his most impressive performer, as None Bettor A – from the hot Jennifer Bongiorno barn – scored in a high-class conditioned pace in a sizzling 1:48.4. None Bettor A has now won four straight and returned \$3.00 to his backers.

Another 1-2 chance would follow in the next race as Stonedust scored in a low-range conditioned pace in 1:51.1 before Callahan guided 1-5 shot McThriller to a dominant score in a mid-range conditioned pace in 1:49.4 in Race 9.

'The Captain' completed his all-chalk four-bagger in the 13th and final race of the night with Colonial Road in a race for pacers with a Trackmaster rating of 76.8 or less in 1:56.4 at odds of 5-2.

Callahan now has 42 winners at the current Big M meeting, good for fourth in the standings.

'THINKBIG' ROLLS: The classy Thinkbig Dreambig – who earned over \$500,000 last year as a 3-year-old – went a third-over trip in a six-horse field and blew by his foes blazing a final quarter in :25.2 to take the featured preferred for 4-year-old pacers.

The son of Bettor's Delight—Extreme Dream, who was driven by Scott Zeron and is trained by Nancy Johansson, stopped the clock in 1:50.2 and returned \$3.40 to his fans as the odds-on choice in the wagering. On Duty was a half-length back in second with Rock Lights third.

A LITTLE MORE: Bongiorno's Albergo Hanover won Race 12 to give the trainer a double on the card... The 50-Cent Pick-4 pool reached six figures for a third straight time as a total of \$104,786 was pushed through the windows... Chalk players had a good time as six winning post-time choices hit the winner's circle... All-source handle totaled \$2,365,844... Racing resumes Friday at 7:15 p.m.

Napolitano and Homicide Hunter reunite in Maxie Lee Invitational

Homicide Hunter and driver George Napolitano Jr. will be reunited this weekend for the first time since their win in October's Breeders Crown Open Trot and the two have proved to be a dynamic duo. Napolitano has driven the trotter 11 times in his career and posted nine victories.

"We get along good," said Napolitano, who will drive 7-year-old Homicide Hunter in today's (May 26) \$100,000 Maxie Lee Invitational for older trotters at Harrah's Philadelphia. "He's just a good ol' horse, it's pretty simple. He's got the heart to win. He always sticks his nose out. He makes it pretty easy for a driver."

Homicide Hunter, history's fastest trotter with a time of 1:48.4 set last year in the Allerage Open Trot at Lexington's Red Mile, is the 3-1 morning-line favorite in the Maxie Lee and will start from post three. He is making his third start of the season and enters off a 1:52.4 victory in a preliminary round of the Great Northeast Open Series at Philly on May 19.

Yannick Gingras, who is in Sweden for the World Driving Championship, drove Homicide Hunter in his first two starts this year for Ron Burke, who took over the training of the horse in April. The gelding was trained the previous three years by Chris Oakes.

Ten of Napolitano's prior drives behind Homicide Hunter came at Napolitano's home track, The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, including victories in the Great Northeast Open Series final and the Breeders Crown. It was the first Breeders Crown triumph for Napolitano, who has won more races at Pocono than any driver in history and was the North American leader in wins in 2010.

"(The Breeders Crown) meant everything," said Napolitano, who has 9,633 wins in his career. "I always wanted to win that big race at my home track, and he led me to it."

Homicide Hunter, owned by Crawford Farms Racing, has won 40 of 80 lifetime starts and earned \$1.73 million in purses. Last year, he had nine victories in 16 races and received the Dan Patch Award for best older male trotter.

"He's a real laid-back, simple horse," Napolitano said. "He's just a cool animal. He's a true champion. He just does his job great."

Will Take Charge is the 4-1 second choice on the Maxie Lee morning line. He will start from post five with Scott Zeron driving for trainer Jeff Gillis. The 6-year-old gelding won the open handicap at Yonkers in his most recent start, May 11.

Guardian Angel As and Cruzado Dela Noche are both 9-2. Guardian Angel As will have Tim Tetrick in the sulky for trainer Anette Lorentzon and starts from post two. He enters off a preliminary round Great Northeast Open Series triumph on May 12. Cruzado Dela Noche, who won the Cutler Memorial on May 4, leaves from post eight with driver Brian Sears for trainer Marcus Melander.

The Maxie Lee Invitational is race 11 on today's card at Harrah's Philadelphia. The track is also playing host to the \$100,000 Betsy Ross Invitational for older female pacers, the \$100,000 Commodore Barry Invitational for older male pacers, and three divisions of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes for 3-year-old male pacers. Racing begins at 12:40 p.m. (EDT).



Top-ranked Hambletonian hopeful Gimpanzee ready for 2019 debut in EBC

Marcus Melander trains the top three horses in the first Road to the Hambletonian rankings released this week by Meadowlands Racetrack announcer/analyst Ken Warkentin, and No. 1 makes his first start of the season Monday (May 27) in the \$215,200 Empire Breeders Classic for 3-year-old male trotters at Vernon Downs.

Gimpanzee, who was nine-for-nine last year and took home the Dan Patch Award for best 2-year-old male trotter, will start from post five in the EBC for Melander and regular driver Brian Sears. Last year, Gimpanzee won seven times on the New York Sire Stakes circuit, including the \$225,000 final, before capturing his elimination and the final of the Breeders Crown.

"He's doing good," Melander said of Gimpanzee, the horse atop Warkentin's rankings, followed by stablemates Greenshoe and Green Manalishi S. "He's filled out nicely. He's not the biggest horse but we've been very happy with him all winter. He doesn't make any noise here at home, he just looks like a regular horse. He's nice and calm. I can't be more excited for his season to start."

Gimpanzee, who earned \$591,358 in purses last season for owners Courant Inc. and S R F Stable, heads to the Empire Breeders Classic off a second-place finish by a head to 2017 Horse of the Year Hannelore Hanover in a qualifier on May 18 at The Meadowlands. The time of the mile was 1:53. The colt also qualified on May 4, winning in 1:55, and on April 27, when he was fifth in 1:58.3.

"Hannelore Hanover just got him at the wire, but we were very happy with his last qualifier," Melander said. "The first qualifier we went with an open bridle and it was a windy day, so maybe that didn't look too impressive, but the last two qualifiers have been very good."

Of the eight remaining horses in the EBC, four are eligible to Hambletonian: Gettin Serious, Star Track Hanover, Mr Vicktor, and Cavill Hanover. Lightly raced Mr Vicktor is 3-for-3 this year for trainer Buzzy Sholty and has won four of five career starts.

Melander was uncertain of Gimpanzee's schedule beyond Monday. He would like his horses to have four or five starts heading to the \$1 million Hambletonian, which is harness racing's top event for 3-year-old trotters and will be held Aug. 3 at The Meadowlands.

"We'll see how he races on Monday and then we'll decide," Melander said. "He's fully staked so we can choose whatever we want to do."

So far, only Greenshoe has made a start this season among Melander's highly regarded trio. Greenshoe won the preliminary round of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for 3-year-old male trotters in 1:51.2 on May 17 at The Meadowlands. Last year, the colt won two of four races, including the NJSS final, despite going off stride in each

start.

"I know the horse is fast, so my only concern was that he was going to behave himself," Melander said. "It looked like he was behaving behind the gate and then in the race he looked perfect. He did a huge race and I couldn't be more happy with him.

"He'll get this week off and we'll aim for the sire stakes final (on May 31). It's a long season and winning in (1):51, I don't think he needs another race between here and the final."

Green Manalishi S, who won five of 10 races last season and never was worse than second, will qualify for the third time this year on Saturday at The Meadowlands. The colt went off stride in his most recent qualifier, May 18 at the Big M, after winning his first in 1:54.1.

"The track is normally very good at The Meadowlands, but it was loose and in the first turn it was just too loose for him and he made a break," Melander said. "He'll be qualifying again this Saturday and then he will race (June 2) at Pocono in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes.

"He's been training down very good. We took a slow start with him because the first sire stakes was at The Meadows and I didn't want to go out there with him. We had a couple of months to prepare him and he feels very prepared. He grew a lot during the winter and filled out nicely. I think he will have a good season."

Gimpanzee's start in the Empire Breeders Classic is expected at approximately 3:29 p.m. (EDT) Monday. The EBC for the male trotters is race nine and will be preceded by the Empire Breeders Classic for 3-year-old female trotters.





Tetrick poised to hit 11,000 wins, and other milestones to watch

Tim Tetrick started Saturday (May 25) with 56,046 starts and was 28 wins shy of 11,000 victories. When he gets those victories, he'll become the 11h to do so — and would need another 50 to move into the top 10 for the first time ever, surpassing Walter Case, Jr. at 11,049.

Meanwhile, **David Miller** is close to joining the 70,000 drives club. Through Friday (May 24), he had 69,236. Already in the club are:

Cat Manzi - 95,690

Tony Morgan - 84,899

Herve Filion - 82,336

Dave Magee - 70,919

Miller is also #5 all-time in victories with 12,682.

Aaron Merriman has moved into #7 all-time in wins with 11,320 surpassing Bill "Zeke" Parker at 13,311.

Seven of the top 12 dash-winning drivers of all time are retired.

Brian Sears is about half-a-million dollars away from cracking the top 5 for the very first time in career earnings.

Brian Sears — \$190,241,901

Mike Lachance — \$190,786,957

Ron Burke is now within 200 wins of the magical 10,000 career mark. He had 9,828 wins starting action on May 25. An average of 2.8 winners a day puts him right at 10,000 on Hambletonian Day. Last Hambletonian Day, Burke surpassed \$200 million.

There are 17 members of the 10,000-win club They are all drivers. Burke is poised to become the first trainer to reach

Rick Zeron is still the richest driving Zeron with \$102,984,884 and 8,137 wins.

Dan Dube, a little less than three weeks from turning 50, has 61,790 drives, 9,042 wins and \$120,287,122 in earnings

Yannick Gingras on Aug. 4 is set to become the richest driver ever to turn 40. He has 40,755 starts, 7,176 and \$171,528,492 in earnings.

Virgil Morgan, Jr. and **Mark Ford** are in a good duel for who has the second most starters of all time (behind Burke, of course).

- Ted Wing was the 1978 Meadowlands leading driver with 178 wins.

The 2016 Hambletonian was not only Zeron's breakthrough in the sports classic event, it was his greatest day. He wrapped up his first Meadowlands driving title that day, surpassed \$50 million in his career, at age 27, won the U S Pacing Championship with Shamballa, for his dad, defeating both Always B Miki and Wiggle It Jiggleit and Zeron won the Hambletonian final by a nose, an indication of what was brewing for Marion Marauder, who won all three Triple Crown legs in a photo.

Marion Marauder well over \$3 million is the richest ever standardbred Triple Crown winner. He also finished second in the \$1 Million International Trot at Yonkers.

Zeron won the freshman pacing colt division with Artspeak and last year won a pair of pacing divisional titles with Nancy Johansson — 2YOCP with Breeders Crown and Governors Cup winner Captain Crunch and the 3YOFP division with Kissin In The Sand. z

The Real Life Ventures and Adventures of Trey and Batman by Trey Nosrac

Plenty of people in this big wide world know my pal as a stoic, rich, 50ish fellow who recently left the netherworld of Silicon Valley. Each day, I realize that deep down he is just like all of us, a child filled with wonder and fears. The more we hang out together, the more his mask slips.

For example, when Batman grows excited, he waves his hands.

When he slipped into my car this morning for a trip to a dentist in Wooster, he began conducting an invisible orchestra as he set out to convince me of a weird concept — slowing down time.

Yesterday, he suggested that viewing a harness race would become an improved experience if each race was slightly delayed and that an additional minute or two would allow gamblers and fans to see races more clearly and allow more time for their brains to process all of the information. Today he gave me additional details and he went crazier.

He slowed his hands to click his seatbelt and got back to funny business, "The speed and power of a trotting horse or a pacing horse are awesome. When a champion trotter is moving at full tilt and I am standing by the rail, their legs are a blur. The speed makes processing both information and optics a challenge for our brains. As the motion slows to the eyes and the brain, the power and majesty of a racing horse are increased. I tried slowing things down in a few crude experiments and believe this to be true."

"How slow are you suggesting?" I asked.

"Certainly not super slow motion. My thinking is that a race could be shown about halfway between real-time and traditional slow motion. I was fooling around with this last night. Frames per second is a complex area, around 60 fps is



common for online streaming. The optimum speed for a harness horse race is an open question. There are many variables to consider, such as the recording device, what the receiving device can support, and how different people process information at different speeds. So, to answer your question, the speed for my idea would need to be scientifically determined."

I cut to the chase and asked, "Do you really think people would get comfortable if they did not see the race at full speed in real time?"

He did not hesitate, "I do. It would be a simple concept to beta test. Remember, this slowed viewing is optional, long time customers need not change anything. Gambling is not changed." Then he came back with another question, "What about you, an avid horse player of long standing, do you think you would try watching your beloved sport a tad more slowly?"

I sighed, took a moment to ponder, and then said, "Yes, as long as the video was only a minute or two behind. What the hell do I care if I learn my fate, or the fate of my wager, at 2:47 p.m. or at 2:49.3 p.m.? To be honest, Trey does not like to be rushed, he is more of an ambler."

My answer seemed to encourage him because his arms were waving again, "Not only would this slight delay improve the excitement of viewing the race, the additional minute or two would open up unbelievable opportunities for AR."

"Arnold Rothstein?"

"No."

"Alex Rodriquez?"

"No."

"Alpha Romeo? I can go on all morning."

He smiled, "Augmented Reality is a technology that superimposes a computer-generated image on a user's view of a real-world event. Augmented reality keeps the

real-world focus on an event, but adds elements that aren't really there to enhance the user's experience."

I wiggled an index finger, "You promised not to go all sci-fi and to stay away from gaming headsets and all that crap."


"No, no, you're confusing augmented reality with virtual reality."

"You're confusing me with Sheldon Cooper and Howard Wolowitz."

He tried to explain in English, "In VR, everything is computer generated. In AR, content from a computer is layered over a real-world environment. AR isn't new technology, you see it every day on television, especially in sports."

"Explain that to me using crayons."

"When you are watching golf and they display a line on the screen that tracks the flight of the ball — that is AR. The player hits the ball, he is real, the swing and the shot are real, but AR allows you to follow the flight, the velocity, the height, the curve, and the distance. There are many examples and types of AR. They are methods of adding digital content on top of a real-world camera view. The intent is to give the



viewer an improved experience."

Scrunching up my face, "Horseracing, I don't know..."

He didn't let me finish. Instead, he handed me his phone and showed me a one-minute video.

I watched the video. Then I handed his phone to him and said, "That's very cool, but those horses were just walking onto the track."

His hands began flapping, "Exactly, TIME is the key to this idea. An AR dashboard like the one in that video is useless DURING a harness race; there is already too much information to process in too little time. The idea is to buy more time, just a little more time."

"He put an index finger on his temple as if shooting for a mind meld and said, "Imagine a race tonight, the race will last 1:54. During that time, the announcer will struggle to include every horse's name. He will identify the leavers and the closers. Good announcers can weave in a few phrases like - Trying to flush out..., Grabbed cover and..., or Taking the long route...

Announcers usually do a fantastic job."

He used his other index finger and another temple for a double mind meld, and continued, "If those announcers had four or five minutes to work with, using my idea of a slightly slower presentation, they could tell a much more compelling story. The race that viewers can now SEE more clearly would be presented with a stronger narrative."

The mind meld was successful. I nodded and said, "And the slower race thing would allow for AR dashboards like the one in that video. You could show stuff like wind direction, wind speed, the exact distance the horse has traveled, individual times for race quarters, and..."

"Whoa, Trey." He opened his arms wide to interrupt my blather. "Welcome to the Starship. I always knew you were a nerd at heart. You see the future; you want to be part of the new world order. You nailed my point - a slightly delayed streaming of a horse race would not negatively affect gambling; it would allow a contemporary view and enhanced experience of your old sport."

I chuckled, "I wouldn't' go that far, and I for sure wouldn't use those words, but maybe you are onto something, maybe our races shouldn't whiz past on jumbled, boring treadmills. Consider me aboard the Starship."





Meadowlands statement on Lasix

In light of the recent circumstances in thoroughbred racing surrounding the welfare of the horses, all of horse racing has come under increased scrutiny. While the rate of catastrophic breakdowns in standardbred racing is but a fraction of what it is with the thoroughbred, the public does not make that distinction.

The health and welfare of our horses has been a top priority throughout president and CEO Jeff Gural's tenure at the Meadowlands and a great deal of time and money has been spent in efforts to eradicate Performance Enhancing Drugs (PEDs) from standardbred racing.

Over the past few months in response to questions on the use of the diuretic Lasix as a PED, a consortium of thoroughbred tracks is taking steps to reduce or eliminate the use of Lasix on race day.

It is the intention of the Meadowlands, as the flagship track of the standardbred industry, to join that movement and proceed in such a way as to insure the best interests of our equine athletes.

A proposal to address the use of Lasix as a race day medication at the Meadowlands has been submitted to the New Jersey Racing Commission (NJRC).

The submitted proposal states that beginning in 2020, no 2-year-old standardbred will be permitted to use Lasix when racing at The Meadowlands. Further, in 2021, the track's signature stakes race, The Meadowlands Pace, will become Lasix free. It is noteworthy that the marquee stake in all of standardbred racing, the Hambletonian at The Meadowlands, has not permitted the use of Lasix throughout its 93-year history.

In discussion with several standardbred trainers, the consensus was that 2-year-old horses should not race with Lasix and should instead be given time away from the track to recover if they are indeed diagnosed with Exercise Induced Pulmonary Hemorrhage (EIPH). Over the entire 2018 season at The Meadowlands, only seven 2-year-olds raced with Lasix .

At the end of the 2021 racing season, we will review these changes, consider any revisions to the practice in thoroughbred racing and adjust as necessary.

While we recognize the therapeutic benefits of Lasix, our concern is with the optics and feel it is important to show that we take the health and safety of our horses very seriously. We believe this is the best approach while we observe how even stricter measures work for the thoroughbred industry.

Kate's Massive dominates Currier & Ives at The Meadows

Kate's Massive powered to the lead past the quarter and made the rest of it look easy, scoring a convincing victory in Friday's (May 24) \$99,430 Currier & Ives for 3-year-old trotters at The Meadows. Last year's Pennsylvania Stallion Series champion, Kate's Massive opened his sophomore campaign with a stallion series victory, so the Currier & Ives represented a step up for him. Nevertheless, Dave Palone steered the son of Muscle Massive—Sister Kate aggressively, protecting the rail starting position and getting away second.

Once Kate's Massive reached the point, he had little trouble holding off the first-over challenge of Shake N Bake. The 6-5 favorite needed only a single tap from Palone's whip in the stretch to defeat Shake N Bake by 2 lengths in 1:54.1, lowering his life mark 1.2 seconds. Long shot Stinglike A B K finished third.

Kelly Paver trains the winner, who lifted his career bankroll to \$136,267, for owner and co-breeder Harry Horowitz.

It was one of five victories on the 12-race card for Palone, who triumphed for the 18th time (including open division wins in final heats and preliminary splits) in the illustrious history of the Currier & Ives, which was launched at The Meadows in 1975. The "winningest" driver in harness racing history, Palone collected his first Currier & Ives victory with Dontellmenomore in 1991.

Also enjoying big nights were Jim Pantaleano and trainer Scott Betts, with four and three wins, respectively.

Following a brief holiday break, live racing at The Meadows resumes Tuesday, first post 1:05 p.m.

Bettor Joy N, Phaetosive win Friday at Big M

Bettor Joy N and Phaetosive emerged victorious in the co-features at the Meadowlands Friday night (May 24).

In the preferred for fillies and mares on the pace, Bettor Joy N raced in third past the half as Kissin In The Sand was rolling along on the lead in a rated :55.4. Bettor Joy N came after the leader from first-over after popping out of the three-hole but was still a length behind at the head of the stretch.

Bettor Joy N, the even-money second choice by a few dollars, then proceeded to wear down Kissin In The Sand (the actual post-time choice) to record a neck win in 1:50.4, a new lifetime best for the 5-year-old daughter of Bettor's Delight—Joyfulbelle. Bettorhaveanother finished third.

Trained by Jim King, Jr. and driven by Tim Tetrick, Bettor Joy N returned \$4.00 to her backers while winning for 15th time from 37 starts, good for lifetime earnings of \$423,634.

In the preferred handicap for trotters, all eyes were on 3-5 favorite and 2017 Horse of the Year Hannelore Hanover, who was making her seasonal debut, but it was another fabulous female, Pennsylvania Sire Stakes terror Phaetosive, who beat the boys with an explosive final eighth of a mile, in 1:52.2.

At the head of the stretch, Phaetosive didn't loom as a big threat, racing well off the rail in fourth, four lengths behind Pappy Go Go, who had made a big move to the lead on the far turn. But trainer/driver Trond Smedshammer got the 4-year-old daughter of Explosive Matter—Phaeton in gear with an eighth to go and rolled past the leader while holding off the late-charging Yes Mickey. Pappy Go Go held third.

Phaetosive lifted her lifetime stats to 12 wins in 19 starts after winning her seasonal debut and has now earned \$876,417. She paid \$24.20 to win as the fifth choice in the betting.

Hannelore Hanover trailed the field past the half and moved to the outside shortly thereafter, but never got close in her first start of the year, finishing last of seven.

A LITTLE MORE: The 20-Cent Can-Am Pick-4 took in \$51,464 in bets, and after a haveable sequence saw winner's odds of 3-1,9-2,3-1 and 9-2, the payoff was \$182.42. Meadowlands TV's Dave Brower gave out the winning combination on the live in-house simulcast show... The on-track 50-Cent Pick-4 reached six figures for a second straight time, as \$100,408 was pushed through the windows. The \$464.30 return followed a sequence of 7-1, 2-1, 9-2 and 9-2 shots... Dave Miller drover four winners on the card... All-source handle totaled \$2,368,877.

Yonkers Pick 5 was a bonanza on Thursday

Yonkers Raceway's Thursday evening (May 23) Pick 5 wager, with a carryover of \$5,420.42, easily leapfrogged its \$15,000 guarantee.

Some \$33,996 worth of fresh investments dove into the pool, thus a total pot (after takeout) of just under \$31,000.

The Pick 5 winning combination of 3/5/2/1/4 saw one lucky lad/lass take it down to the tune of \$30,917.25.

The Pick 5 is a 50-cent base wager comprising either races 6 through 10 (if 10 races) or 7 through 11 (if more than 10 races) each racing program. It has no consolation payoff, meaning if no one selects all five winners, the entire pool (minus takeout) moves to the next card.

Tell Me Its Summer sets national season's mark at Harrah's Hoosier Park

Tell Me Its Summer and driver, trainer LeWayne Miller continued their winning ways at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino after capturing the \$18,000 Go On BB Series Final on Thursday, May 23. Tell Me Its Summer prevailed in a tight photo to score in 1:50.3, extending her win streak to six and also remains undefeated this season. The 1:50.3 clocking established a national season's mark for three-year-old pacing fillies on a seven-eighths mile oval and was a new lifetime best for the sophomore filly.

After drawing to the outside in her last three starts, Tell Me Its Summer left from the coveted rail position in a talented field of 10. Unhurried from the gate, Miller settled the filly along the rail in sixth. Sam Widger had Kinda Like Kori on a mission to the front and she dictated snappy, first half fractions of :25.3 and :53.4. Lady Capulet and Trace Tetrick were the first to commit to the outer flow and began their long, first-over grind just past the half. Miller quickly grabbed the cover and had Tell Me Its Summer in perfect striking position, second-over.

As the field reached the third station in 1:23.1, the quick pace began to take its toll on the leader. Lady Capulet had reached command turning for home and braced for the cavalry charge behind her. Tell Me Its Summer tipped out late in the lane and was able to put a nose in front as four fillies hit the wire together. Sage Ivy and Dale Hiteman came storming home to get up for second place honors while Lady Capulet battled gamely to hold on for third. As the heavy betting favorite, Tell Me Its Summer returned \$3.40 to her backers at the betting windows.

"I really wasn't sure how the race was going to work out," Miller said after the victory. "I knew she would fight them off if she had to but the trip ended up working out perfect for us. I didn't think they would go that much but she loves to race off a helmet.

"Her last start she really impressed me. It was a sloppy night and she went a big mile. She has her issues but she gets better with every start and I still think there is room for improvement with her."

With the win, Tell Me Its Summer increased her lifetime to bankroll to \$34,250. Sired by Tellitlikeitis, the homebred filly is owned by Victory Hill Farm. Tell Me Its Summer is scheduled to make her next start in Indiana Sires Stakes action which is set to kick-off next at Harrah's Hoosier Park next week.

Done Well to Camluck Classic

Less than 24 hours after capturing the 41st edition of the Confederation Cup at Flamboro Downs, trainer Ron Burke confirmed that Done Well will participate in this year's Camluck Classic on closing night, May 31st at The Raceway at Western Fair District.

The son of Well Said has now posted back-to-back wins following a 1:50.2 lifetime best over Flamboro and is sure to be a major threat in this year's \$157,000 contest.

The gelding has more than \$583,000 earned in his career and has started off his 4-year-old campaign with a record of 2-1-0 from a trio of starts.

The Raceway is also proud to announce that the connections of Trump Nation and The Wall have accepted invitations to the Camluck Classic.

Trump Nation, who captured the 2018 edition of the Art Rooney, is fresh off a sizzling 1:49.3 winning effort at The Meadowlands. He will line up in the Camluck Classic for trainer Andrew Harris, himself a native of Ontario who now operates a large stable in New Jersey.

The pacer's sire, Betterthancheddar, competed in what was then the Molson Pace at Western Fair in 2013 finishing a strong second behind State Treasurer. Trump Nation has a 10-3-3 record from 22 starts in his career with \$322,000 in the bank.

The Wall, trained by Nick Surick, is also confirmed for this year's Camluck Classic. The son of Somebeachsomewhere captured two legs of this year's George Morton Levy Series at Yonkers Raceway and has nearly \$340,000 banked in his young career.

The 5-year-old boasts a record of 1:51.2 taken earlier this year at Yonkers Raceway and will be handled by his regular

pilot Joe Bongiorno on May 31.

The other big news is that harness racing's winningest driver Dave Palone will make the trip to Ontario to drive Southwind Amazon in the Camluck Classic. Palone has put up amazing numbers during his career including more than 18,800 trips to the winner's circle. PASS for trotting fillies at Pocono tonight

The northbound lanes of the Northeast Extension of the Pennsylvania Turnpike will be a very busy place just before suppertime tonight, as horsemen competing in the big card at Philly in the afternoon will then be making their way 100 miles to The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, for third preliminary round action in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes and Stallion Series for 3-year-old trotting fillies.

In the fifth race first division, like the other pair worth \$55,168, Sonnet Grace has been accorded early favoritism as she starts from post five for trainer Ron Burke and driver Matt Kakaley. The Muscle Massive filly, whose granddam is

the great CR Kay Suzie, was victorious in a Sire Stake in her first start of the year, then miscued in a PASS contest at The Meadows last week. Sonnet Grace will look to bounce back Sunday, with among her opposition Hallintheclouds, who also had a first round Sire Stakes triumph.

The 10th-race second division will feature the second start of 2019, after a thumping 1:52 victory at the Meadowlands, of the Explosive Matter filly The Ice Dutchess, who was generally regarded as second-best filly in her class last year behind the talented Woodside Charm. A five-time winner with earnings of \$424,540 last year, The Ice Dutchess will have to begin from the outside post seven for driver Scott Zeron and trainer Nancy Johansson; three horses who are already Sire Stakes winners this year – Asiago, Jazzy Fashion, and Antonia – may provide formidable opposition.

The 11th-race third division features the only double Sire Stakes winner in this group to date, the Possess The Will filly Millies Possesion, who is also undefeated in three career starts for driver Dexter Dunn and trainer Jim Campbell. Like The Ice Dutchess, the unbeaten miss must overcome the outermost starting slot in the seven-horse field; equine difficulty may come from Firedbylindie, a PaSS winner at The Meadows, and Beautiful Sun, a \$480,000 yearling, who had three wins and two seconds at two and who makes her seasonal bow tonight.

In the Stallion Series competition, the two double winners in the group so far are the morning line favorites in the first and last of four StS sections, which are each going for \$20,000. Keystone Abbey will start from post six in the fourth race section for driver George Napolitano Jr. and trainer Chris Beaver; Spring In Paris, 6-fot-7 this year, will be in starting slot number two in the twelfth race for driver Corey Callahan and trainer Steve LeBlanc.

Harness racing, a study in self-inflicted pain

A close look at harness racing's current issue of declining bettors can be summed up with just a handful of words "ignore at your own peril". Issues were placed squarely on harness racing's front lawn years ago and it has chosen to ignore them. Tapping into the casino profits from slots should have been utilized as a temporary opportunity to fix problems while remaining profitable. But, harness racing in its infinite wisdom, chose to sit back and do little if anything, validating the old axiom: "to keep repeatably doing something the same way and expecting different results is the definition of insanity." Even thoroughbred issues came to light recently with the running of the 2019 Kentucky Derby. Why did it take 30 minutes to find an interference call when both the rules and the infraction were clear? And, why didn't the iockeys that were interfered with lodge the obvious objection immediately, the answer is both politics and profitability.

Harness racing, like baseball, has chosen to ignore the game and concentrate on politics and profits. Today's fans and bettors are much more highly educated and expect a product that provides a level playing field to all bettors with a reasonable chance to make a couple of bucks while providing non-stop entertainment. Need a clear picture, compare the customer experience at an NBA or NFL game with that at a baseball game, now you see the issue with current harness racing and you begin to see the problem in developing new, younger betting customers which have come to expect more non-stop entertainment. Two of the largest-handle tracks have gone to providing free PP's and handicapping discussion prior to and between races, while the majority are still stuck in 1970 playing loud rock music and running wiener dog races or shooting t-shirts into the crowd.

If we look at the sport from 50,000 feet, several tracks are prospering right now, but it is my belief their profitability is currently tied to an influx of customers formerly wagering at many of the smaller tracks. Without significant, fundamental changes the harness racing sport is on a decay curve

heading towards flat in the next 5-7 years. If the track CEOs think they have a secure business model, perhaps they need to look at the track in Yonkers, NY. Initially, slots profits infused into purse money drew the best drivers, trainers and horses now the track's hold or take-out on wagering dollars has fallen to less than the purse paid out and changes made to racing conditions has made the racing predictable and boring.

So what does a racetrack look like that would draw my wagering dollars:

- 1. Lower takeout rates, there is no reason other than greed that the PA tracks have a takeout rate up to twice that of a casino and other tracks are gradually raising theirs, where allowed.
- 2. Adopt a standard set of rules instead of "Well he only went inside of one pylon and he really didn't mean to go off the racing surface and come back on it."
 - 3. Form reversal is absolutely NOT permitted.
- 4. Every racing program should display up to date fines and suspensions for each driver and horse and it should be displayed on each race's stats.
- 5. Wagering and odds should be handled in a way that does NOT allow advantages to the last-minute, super large

bettors. Frankly, this is one area the tracks have chosen to look the other way on and I'm tired of wagering on a horse at 7-5 at just before the off only to find after the first turn some 30 seconds later that a whale bettor has driven the odds down to 3-5. You, I and the tracks know that it is a simple programming task of XOXO's to disallow super bets after a certain time in the betting cycle. This respects all customers equally.

6. It's obvious that in the big money races that many of the better horses are not extended fully in the previous week's elimination races. While this understandable, it is not fair to the betting public, thus elimination races should be deemed/carded NON-BETTING.

7. As the horse are preparing to get behind the gate, I'm bothered by the drivers' conversations, the optics are bad. Drivers making holes to let other drivers stuck on the outside into is unacceptable to me.
