Solvalla's sparkling weekend show, with today's (May 28) Elitloppet as the highlight, had a great start when the \$135,000 Sweden Cup was held on Saturday's (May 27) card.

Three elimination heats were held and Tomas Malmqvist-trained **Invictus Madiba** (Booster Winner) impressed in the first race as he disarmed leading favorite Bepi Bi in the stretch.

Iceland Falls (Iceland) impressed as much in her elimination. A first over trip didn't stop her from being strongest and **Four Guys Dream** (Dream Vacation) claimed the last elimination from the lead.

No Alessandro Gocciadoro horses won in the heats, but in the final, he had three weapons in Bepi Bi, **Bengurion Jet** and Synergy (nicely driven by Dexter Dunn in the elimination).

Iceland Falls opened quickly for the lead when the car left the field in the final, but an eager Bepi Bi on the outside made the race high paced and the leader was never allowed to rest during the journey.

Italian-bred Callmethebreeze attacked from second over in the middle of the last turn and four wide Bengurion Jet got the signal from Alessandro Gocciadoro at the same time. Iceland Falls battled bravely but she was marked by the high pace and Callmethebreeze and Bengurion Jet were the horses that fought for the win as the wire approached.

Bengurion Jet caught the Sweden Cup trophy in 1:51.3 and this particular race is something that Gocciadoro often wins. Last year, his Bepi Bi was outstanding in both elimination and final and earlier years he's been successful with Arazi Boko.

Callmethebreeze was a good runner up and Iceland Falls a very brave bronze medalist.

DJUSE AND MALMQVIST SUCCEEDED IN HARPER HANOVERS

The \$187,500 Harper Hanovers race over 3,140 meters is traditionally one of Elitloppet weekend's most thrilling races and this year's edition became a great success for trainer Tomas Malmqvist and driver Magnus A Djuse. **Eric The Eel** (Muscle

Hill) with merits from France, got a trip far back in the field and Djuse followed behind horses three wide when a kilometer remained of the race.

Imperatur Am and Kentucky River, both among the race's favorites, were the two front horses and leader Imperatur Am's driver, Magnus Teien Gundersen, tried to speed up the game the longer the race went on, but outside trotter Kentucky River was hard to get rid of and when they turned for home, it seemed like one of these two trotters would be the winner. Instead, Eric The Eel finished strongly from the far outside and Malmqvist's horse came home in a mile rate of 1:56 over 1.9 miles.

Kentucky River held strongly as runner up and leader Imperatur Am was third.

IDAO DE TILLARD IS BACK

Idao de Tillard (Severino) was one of the favorites to win the Prix d'Amérique in Paris in January and the Thierry Duvaldestintrained trotter made his comeback at the track on Friday (May 26) night at Vincennes.

A perfect second over trip and a quick attack towards leader Elie de Beaufour 600 meters to go resulted in a tight, but safe win in strong mile rate 1:56.2 over 1.7 miles.

Dexter Dunn showed up at Solvalla on Saturday's race card and his first drives in Sweden were impressive. Longshot Synergy finished third and qualified for the Sweden Cup final after a perfect drive on Dunn's part. In the Lady Snärts lopp, Dunn was entrusted with German trotter Riet Hazelaar and after a spotless performance by Dunn, the duo finished second behind a superior Zeudi Amg (Alessandro Gocciadoro).

"I'm enjoying this event and my journey very much. I'm satisfied with everything so far and the atmosphere is fantastic here at Solvalla," said Dunn after the final of the Sweden Cup where he finished last with Synergy.



TALES FROM THE CURMUDGEON

Luc Blais' passion and determination led to success

If one were to ask Luc Blais for a one-word description of his love and association with harness racing, that word would be passion.

"Without passion in this sport you might conceivably become successful in harness racing, but the possibility of that becoming a reality is far less than it would be if you had it," Blais said. "As for me, having spent a lifetime in the sport, I've yet to encounter anybody who has been successful who has not had a genuine love and passion for the sport."

The native of the Quebec is in charge of the racing stable of Serge Godin's Determination.

"It is truly a dream come true for me," Blais said. "I would never in my greatest imagination have dreamed that I would be experiencing what I have been living since I went to work for Monsieur Godin."

Let's start at the beginning. When were you first introduced to harness racing?

"The reality is that I have always been involved in the sport. My dad trained and raced at Connaught Park and Rideau Carleton. My brother also raced there. So did my uncle. We would regularly go to small venues throughout Quebec where our family would spend a Sunday afternoon competing in and watching racing. My mother would

pack a picnic basket and it would be a great way to spend a day. The purses were generally not of any consequence. There were times when there no purses at all. We might just be racing for a blanket or the proverbial bag of oats. I look back on those days as some of the best of my life."

Let's explore the timeline. How did you progress from a small Quebec stable to being the custodian of arguably the most important privately-owned stable in all of harness racing?

"Actually, it was quite some time before I even had my own small stable. I started the way most people in the business do. I was a groom. I worked for several trainers both in Canada and the United States. I suppose the turning point in my career occurred when I went to work for Yves Filion's Bayama Farms. It gave me the opportunity to not only work for and with a great Hall of

Fame horseman, but to also work with well-bred youngsters on their route to occasionally becoming champions.

"It was there that I realized that working with babies was the most satisfying and sometimes among the most challenging things I had ever done. I resolved that if I ever had the opportunity to do this on my own, I would latch onto the chance. Little did I know how lucky I would become."

One would think that the turning point in your training career was with the trotter Intimidate.

"Without a doubt that was the case. The Intimidate story would likely make a great script for a movie. I was on my own making a living in the sport, but just that. Judith Farrow bred and raised Intimidate. I also had a part in raising him. Almost from the time he was foaled I would track his progress at Ms. Farrow's farm.

From the first time that I encountered him I became part of his life and just as importantly he became a big part of mine. Together with my son, we broke him and lived the dream all the way to his exciting Breeders Crown win. That Breeders Crown race will always be one the greatest thrills of my life. Moreover, looking back I would have to think that Intimidate's success might have paved my way to getting the opportunity to train Mr. Godin's horses. Intimidate is now retired at Ms. Farrow's farm, living the good life as a pensioner."

Intimidate is obviously one of your favorite horses, do you have any others?

"My favorites constitute a triple dead heat between Intimidate, Forbidden Trade and Emoticon Hanover. They were all terrific champions. It is quite difficult, if not impossible, to choose between them."

Let's start with Forbidden Trade. You won the Hambletonian with the first horse you started in the race. Many were surprised. Were you?

"At the risk of sounding as though I'm bragging, the answer would be not really. Once he qualified for the final, I felt he had as good a chance as any of the others. He is a wonderful horse; very well focused with a very stable nervous system. The Hambletonian is a race quite different than most others. Horses racing in it are usually doing something that they've never done before. They are racing in the day time before a large crowd. They are also being subject to more media attention than ever before. Not all horses take to that kindly. I knew that Forbidden Trade would. I remember telling my brother before the race that he had overcome his greatest obstacle which was in making the final. I felt that he was as sharp as he'd ever been. He always came to race. I felt that if things did not go against us that we had a good shot."

How about Emoticon Hanover?

"She was a truly wonderful filly. She acted as though she were special right from the very beginning. We raced her five years through 74 races. She earned \$1,778,033. She never once went a bad race; not once. We are now training her first foal a 2-year-old Muscle Hill filly who seems quite promising."

Let's turn to yearlings. Mr. Godin and your team do as thorough a job in shopping as anybody out there. Do you have any trade secrets?

"We do what I presume most good yearling shoppers do. We study the catalogs. We focus on the pedigrees that most appeal

to us. We watch them in the paddock. We look at the videos. Of course, we evaluate the conformation and the soundness of the yearlings. I suppose that if I do something that most others may not do, it is that I look for the 'It' factor. I need to like the yearling for other than physical factors. You might almost call it psychic. The horse needs to reach out and appeal to me. I need to have a connection between it and me."

Let's turn to your peers. Are there any trainers out there that you respect more than others?

"There are a good many excellent trainers. One that comes immediately to mind is Jim Campbell. He doesn't have a giant stable. He does things pretty much the way I like to think that I try to do them. I feel he lets the horses dictate what he is going to do with them, rather than him determining a set course that might not correspond to what is best for the horse. Year after year he has excellent horses that do well. That is no accident. I first noticed him when he was prepping Tagliabue for the Hambletonian. I've tried to emulate him since."

How do things stack up for the Determination stable in 2023?

"I'm very optimistic. We started with 40 head, the largest number we have ever had. They are all still going. Twenty-four of them are 2-year-olds. I believe that they are the finest bunch we have ever had. We train here at Classy Lane Training Center not too far from Mohawk. I believe it's the best of its kind in the area. They have an excellent well-maintained racetrack. We've been between 2:10 and 2:13 with the 2-year-olds. At this stage, we don't believe in asking for speed. We stress conditioning and soundness, in both mind and body.

"We will train them to the bike for the first-time next week and go on from there. I don't anticipate starting them until mid-June and perhaps a little later. The racing schedule is skewed so that a great deal of money and prestige comes later in the season. We are not in any big hurry."

You are a Quebecois. Do you miss La Belle Province?

"Yes. Very much so. That is where my history, my family and culture come from. I think that the greatest loss for harness racing in Canada happened when they stopped racing in Montreal. At one time it was Canada's capital for the sport. Now there is nothing there. I look upon it as a great tragedy."

David Allan Whoa carries momentum into Indiana Sires Stakes opener

Last October, then-freshman pacer David Allan Whoa competed on the lucrative Hoosier Champions Night card. He narrowly missed out on battling for the top prize in a \$250,000 Super Final, instead competing in, and nearly winning, a \$25,000 consolation. Trainer Joe Putnam is optimistic his sophomore can carry this year's early-season momentum into Monday's (May 29) opening round of Indiana Sires Stakes (ISS) action at Harrah's Hoosier Park. A good showing on Memorial Day would provide valuable points right out of the gate in a long sires stakes campaign.

"That's what we're hoping," Putnam said. "We've had a nice prep leading up to the sires stakes. I think we've got a colt that will be competitive. That's all you can ask for."

David Allan Whoa has drawn into the 10th race on Hoosier Park's special Memorial Day card, the \$50,000 first division of ISS competition for sophomore colt pacers. It will mark the gelding's fourth seasonal start. He enters the race with two wins to his credit, the latest a 1:50.4 effort in the \$22,000 Hal Dale final held May 20.

"Our plan worked out well so far," Putnam said. "We didn't really want to be ready until around the first of May. We knew our colt didn't race too much last year, so we were hoping to get three of four starts heading into sires stakes. Luckily, we only won one race last year, so we fit one of the early closers and that worked out great for us. The colt raced very well and won the final impressively."

Despite only one trip to the winner's circle last season, the owner took note of his pupil's ability. David Allan Whoa managed to hit the board in six of 11 attempts. Perhaps with a little more luck and a better finish in one of his sires stakes starts, the pacer could have qualified for the Super Final last fall. Putnam was not disappointed in the gelding's season. Quite the opposite, in fact. The Randy Wilt-bred son of Tellitlikeitis—Cinnamon Girl banked \$41,840 and registered a beaten time of 1:50.3 over the Anderson oval.

"Training down as a 2-year-old we knew the colt had some talent," Putnam said. "It just took him a while to mentally and physically develop, so he was a little slow getting started. As

the year wore on, he improved pretty much every start. We just missed the sires stakes final by a point. We ended up in the consolation, which was fine. He got beat by a nose in the consolation. He had a pretty good year, and we were happy with the way he finished the year. We shut him down fairly early and let him grow up. So far, he's come back pretty nice as a 3-year-old."

After two qualifying efforts with son Joey at the lines, the sophomore made his debut for Putnam's J P Racing, LLC on April 28 in a non-winners of two event with a purse of \$14,000. David Allan Whoa held on by a neck in a time of 1:51.2. The gelding was back in action May 5, finishing second in the opening leg of the Hal Dale Series. Fifteen days later he scored his 1:50.4 triumph, taking command from post 6 and kicking home in :26.4 as the favorite, clear of the field by just over two lengths.

"We knew he had talent," Putnam said. "Obviously, to race at the top level you need a lot of talent. We were hoping he would be a colt that could compete in sires stakes. So far, it looks like he's going to be competitive, so we're happy."

Monday's event will serve as an early test. David Allan Whoa has drawn post 5. To his immediate inside is the Erv Miller-trained Coach Stefanos, runner-up in last year's Super Final and 2022 Indiana Sired freshman champion. He is one of four Super Final starters in the field of eight. The \$49,500 second division (race 12) features a group of seven, headlined by 2022 Super Final winner Buzzsaw Russ.

"The 3-year-old boys are always a rugged bunch," Putnam said. "The numbers in the divisions I thought were a little light just getting started, but the quality is awful deep."

A \$32,000 yearling purchase at the Hoosier Classic sale, David Allan Whoa has earned \$62,590 to date. According to his trainer, he has all the tools to be a good horse and compete with the best in the Hoosier State this season.

"He's kind of a pistol," he said. "He's got a good personality. He's a very well-made horse. He looks like the Tellitilikeitis line. He's strong, very stout, good-gaited, doesn't wear any boots, and he's got a good attitude. He loves racing. I think he'll be a nice horse not only for this year, hopefully, but I think he could have a future as a nice racehorse."


Putnam would love to see his charge develop into Indiana's next top sophomore pacing star, but he is also playing the long game. He would also like to have a top horse for the next several seasons. He has had success guiding Indiana-sired talent to the

top of their classes and then kept them there for several years. He conditioned millionaire trotter and multiple Indiana Sires Stakes champion ABC Mercedes, and he is navigating pacing mare Rockin Nola through a campaign that could see her eclipse seven figures by season's end.

"I look at the whole picture," Putnam said. "Obviously your 3-yearold year is probably the most lucrative of money events. But we try to develop horses for the long run. There's certainly nothing wrong with having a really nice overnight horse. At this point, he looks like the type of horse that could develop into an opencaliber pacer. We're definitely looking to the future as well."

Hoosier Park's Memorial Day program kicks off at 6:15 p.m. The card includes eight Indiana Sires Stakes contests for sophomores with two divisions apiece.







Trainer Chantal Mitchell, \$5 million and counting

Personal milestones are secondary for Chantal Mitchell. The Waterdown, ON trainer said she was pleasantly surprised to have reached two in a May 13 victory at Woodbine Mohawk Park, when 3-year-old pacing filly Freshen Up (3, 1:52.0s; \$114,348) lowered her lifetime mark for driver James MacDonald.

"I guess in the grand scheme of things, it's not really a huge feat," Mitchell said. "But for me, it's interesting, because I went over 300 wins and \$5 million the same race."

It was her partner in work and life who pointed out the achievement.

"Actually Kris [DiCenzo] is the one who said to me, 'That was 300!" Mitchell said. "Because you pay attention, but then you don't win a whole bunch. You come through a dry spell when you don't win a race, and then you forget about it."

The win by Freshen Up (Bettors Delight—Fresh Look), owned by Eric Good of Davidsonville, MD and Frank Canzone of Scarsdale, NY, was Mitchell's 13th training win from 63 starts so far this year. The filly followed up with a show finish in Saturday's (May 20) \$129,500 SBOA divisional final.

Mitchell said she likes developing horses, including those requiring patience to reach their potential.

"We were just picking up a 3-year-old that was injured earlier in the season," she said. "We're just bringing him in to start back. He's a 3-year-old Bettors Delight, owned by Tom Hill. He never did make it. He needed some extra time."

She learned how to look after racehorses from an early age.

"My dad worked with standardbreds and so I started going to the barn with him in the summertime," she said. "I worked for Daniel Martin during my summer holidays and on weekends. After high school, I started doing more of it. I ended up, in the summer of 2005, I got my own horse, just a cheap 3-year-old that didn't make it. I tinkered with her and brought her along, so that's when I got my trainer's license, to try to start her. And I just kept going."



Mitchell has since built a strong resume at Woodbine Mohawk Park, with some well-known stakes' performers raising her profile.

"Bettors Wish [p, 4, 1:47.3m; \$2,601,233,2019 Dan Patch 3-Year-Old Pacing Colt of the Year/2020 Older Pacing Horse of the Year] would be one of my favorites," she said. "He was just a nice horse to be around and a really nice racehorse. But if you were to look at the horse who's probably done the most for my career, that would be [2019 O'Brien 2-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year] Alicorn [p, 2, 1:50.3s; \$561,140]. I would have to say those two would be maybe tied there. They'd be some of my favorites that I've gotten to train."

Her success is reflected in the growth of the stable she operates with DiCenzo.

"It's just one big team," Mitchell said. "For the most part, we've always had a barn of between 10-15, and just in maybe the last five years, we've gone 15 to 20. Altogether, we have 22 in the barn right now... The only older horses are Ario Hanover [p, 3, 1:49.4s; \$156,205] and Oney Hall [5, 1:51.0s; \$419,116], and now we had an owner send us an Australian import, but he's been sick, so he hasn't raced for us yet. The rest are all 2- and 3-year-olds."

I guess in the grand scheme of things, it's not really a huge feat. But for me, it's interesting, because I went over 300 wins and \$5 million the same race.

She said the Australian pacer is a 6-year-old who faced obstacles to getting established here.

"His name is Uncle Shank A [p, 6, Q1:50.4m; \$120,243]," Mitchell said. "He won 16 of 30 and did pretty well for them down there... He was actually with Linda Toscano when he first came over. She raced him twice and she felt that he would benefit more from the racing style at Mohawk. She suggested the owner [Kevin Harvey of Ingramport, NS] send him here. Then of course, once he got here, the weather was terrible and there's sickness going around. With him being a little more sensitive, he's been really sick. I think we're winning the battle, but it's been a long one."

Mitchell and DiCenzo's trainees are stabled at Classy Lane Training Centre in Puslinch, ON.

"A lot of them are horses that don't necessarily race, because we train a lot of young horses, so we're not racing those campaigners that race 35 starts a year," she said. "We did have Pointomygranson [p,5,1:49.4s; \$583,978]. He was one of those for the last six years, and we just moved him along to Yonkers to race in claimers. He was a good one. He showed up every Saturday night and won 32 races for us on the circuit here."

Mitchell said she likes to take it slow with young horses, for owners with the same philosophy.

"Typically, we're not ready quite as early, at the very beginning," she said. "It's just the way we train them; we take our time a little more. We had a few that were on that schedule to be ready early, and then we got hit with the sickness in the barn and missed about two weeks of training... They might be better for it, in the long run.

"We're never really worried about having them ready for the first stakes race of the season. If they're ready, great, but we're not going to push them. You hear a lot of people like, 'Stakes payments are coming up, we've gotta train, we can't miss this day, we're on a schedule.' Look, to me, the horse makes the schedule... When it comes to training them down and getting them there, they tell you when they're ready. When you push them, it doesn't usually end well."

There are currently 14 2-year-olds in training with Mitchell and DiCenzo.


"It's still early, but we've got a few that we like," she said. "We've got a Stag Party filly and a Jimmy Freight gelding going really well. We have a few by first-crop stallions: Bettors Wish; we had a McWicked. They're interesting because you don't know what they are. If you train a Bettors Delight, you know their tendencies. They don't always train great, so one that's just training average, you don't really worry about them. You wait until they get behind the gate. Whereas first-crop sires, you don't know what they are yet, but as of right now, they've been in 2:15 and doing it really well, so they're exciting."

Building back at the same training center where Mitchell lost all but one horse in a tragic 2016 fire is meaningful every day.

"We moved back into the barn once they rebuilt it, and it's nice to see the memorial there," she said. "We have lots of reminders about everything, but it's business as usual, really."







Is harness racing becoming a "club sport"?

Whether the perception is real or not, it could reach a tipping point.

I saw a tweet this week from long-time harness racing player Greg Schuler.

It's not the first time I have — and I expect you have, too — heard this point of view.



When we see line-up races at Yonkers – which I think we have more often than in the old days – I don't think anyone can deny it's the 'wait until we get a better post and race next week' phenomenon.

When we witness drivers who have live horses sit a three hole at Mohawk or Hoosier rather than pull a right line, I think we all believe it's cut from the same cloth.

When we watch a Meadowlands maiden race with eight horses off qualifiers with only one of the horses bet off the board, we often see all other drivers saying whoa off the car, which is not dissimilar.

Yes, we can complain and argue with Schuler, no doubt many will, and some of it is perception versus reality. But I think we have our heads fully deposited in the hay if we didn't grant at least some truth to his argument.

At the thoroughbreds, for the most part, we do not see these same complaints. Part of it is certainly because they race fewer times. A horse at Yonkers can take a week off with near impunity. If a thoroughbred racehorse does, the monthly bills don't get paid. But I think it's more than that.

In thoroughbred maiden races, for example, the connections of assorted starters haven't heard about Linda Toscano's high-priced yearling who has a ton of talent, nor have they qualified against her horse. This shows, because when that horse is in the box against eight or nine others on debut, those jocks and trainers are saying anything but whoa when the gates open.

Illustrated statistically, Bob Baffert, Todd Pletcher and Chad Brown are trainers who get the highest-priced yearlings, as well as six or seven figure horses from the 2-year-old sales who work bullets and have tons of talent. Over the past year, their first-time starters won only 18 per cent of time.

Even if these potential superstars are bet down to 3-1 or lower — where everyone from the clockers to hotwalkers seems to know something — they only win 29 per cent of the time.

No matter what the statistic, there are no races off, no passing lanes, no three holes to sit, and no horses to avoid. And I suspect it's one reason why the handle at the runners is so much more vibrant.

Maybe this is much ado about nothing. Schuler can play Churchill and we can simply forget about him, but as Bobby Chang a vice-president of the Hong Kong Jockey Club noted back in 2007 when their racing was losing customers: "when people stop betting the sport, many leave and don't come back." It was the catalyst for them to address the issues.

In our sport, we do have a few Bobby Changs, and they've been proactive.

People like John Campbell have been working on uniform racing rules for years, in part because this phenomenon is a threat to the sport.

Jeff Gural and The Meadowlands team have relentlessly tried an experiment regarding the giving of holes, slow quarters and eliminating the clogging of the flow, to combat exactly what Schuler speaks of.

We know of judges at some venues who have called up drivers for explanations when they took a well-bet horse back to last, or sat a three hole at 4-5 while climbing over the horses in front of them.

Folks like Gural may make moves that fall flat. The judges might be off-base and off-putting on something, and John Campbell might not choose the right rule to fix in the right way.

But each of them undoubtedly sees the danger of harness racing becoming a club sport. And I think by being proactive, they are not only addressing the perception, but the reality, too.





Fourth-generation horse person Dawn Gray continues her dad's legacy

That her horse racing life has come full circle isn't lost on Dawn Gray.

It was less than a month ago when she walked into the barn of Jimmy Nickerson on what was her first official day of working for the long-time trainer.

"I remember that Jimmy said to me, 'How happy would your father be to see this?' It really meant a lot hearing that," Gray said.

Gray, who lost her father, respected horseman Robert Gray, in 2018, found herself back in familiar surroundings when she took on a groom role at the Nickerson standardbred operation.

It was Jimmy and Heidi Nickerson who helped bring out her passion for racing and its equine stars.

"I'm a fourth-generation horse person," Dawn said. "It goes back to my great-grandfather, my grandparents, my parents... my entire family has been involved in some way, shape or form. So, I guess I was born into it, something that I would fall in love with. And I did. You could always find me at the barn when I was a kid. When I started cleaning stalls for my dad, who always had a few horses, I think working alongside him was when racing and the horses really clicked for me."

The Nickersons helped keep that connection rolling along.

"What really elevated everything for me was when my dad was working for Jimmy and Heidi at Scarborough Downs," Dawn said. "I was around 15 and I would go there and clean stalls for them. They took me under their wing and started to teach me more and more about the horses. It was just so much fun and my connection to the horses really took off from that point."

There have been several highlights for Dawn throughout her 15-plus years in the sport.

The native of Maine has had the good fortune to cross paths with some of the most talented pacers and trotters in recent times, including one of the most decorated harness horses of all times.

"I've been given a lot of amazing opportunities to work with incredible horses," she said. "A few years ago, I worked with Evenin Of Pleasure when he won the [2018] Gerrity at Saratoga. I paddocked him that night. When [leading standardbred moneywinner of all time] Foiled Again was on his farewell tour, when he came to my home state of Maine, I got the call to take care of him that day of his tour."

But for Dawn, the moments spent with her father on the smaller circuits in her home state is what she most treasures.

Those times are never far from her thoughts.

"About 10 years ago, my dad had a stable of 20 horses, and it was just me and him," Dawn said. "Those moments for me are the most heartfelt ones. Even though I've been around highly decorated, fast, well-bred horses, it was the smaller moments with my dad that stand out for me. It was those times at small tracks in Maine that have stuck with me. I'm thankful for those days, to be together and have success."

Dawn is also thankful for the chance to continue her affinity for racing with a couple who continue to foster her unabashed love of all things standardbred.

"My dad worked for the Nickerson family for years and in his final weeks, he was working for them," Dawn said. "It's this bittersweet, full circle thing. I'm working where my dad worked with the people who taught me a lot about the sport

They are also getting a quality person, someone who remains a popular figure within the horse racing community.

On a night where Dawn doesn't have any horses on the card, she will often still be found rail side, cheering on her friends' horses.

Even when she's not seen, she is certainly heard in the grandstand and beyond.

"I'm everybody's cheerleader," she said. "Even if we don't have a horse in a race, I'm cheering for my friends. A little while ago, one of my friend's horses was racing and I'm cheering and being very loud. After the race was over, a few people came up to me, who had been standing at the other side of the racetrack and said they could hear me cheering for the horse."

These days, Dawn is taking time to be her own biggest cheerleader.

Her pursuit of a contented life inside and outside of the racetrack is still a work in progress, but she's happy where she finds herself, buoyed by the belief she is on a good path.

"I've dedicated a huge part of my life to the horses and contributing to the success of people and the owners I work



for," Dawn said. "I would say I don't have a lot that I do outside of horse racing, but I'm really trying to prioritize having a happy work life, but also flourishing a lot more in my personal life.

"I've always been the friend who if you are up for a road trip, I'm there. If you want to go out and dancing and have a drink, I'm the friend you call. So, I don't have hobbies, so to speak, but I'm always down for an adventure, whatever that might be. You never know where I might wind up. I'm just trying to find that work/life balance. That's where I am in my life."

All of it music to her ears, quite literally, on most days.

"A good day at the barn for me is when the horses are happy and healthy, that everyone got out and got everything they needed," Dawn said. "Good vibes all around. When I'm in the barn, I like to have my music going and get all that I can with my one-on-one time with the horses. For me, a good day would be running my hands over every horse, looking every horse over, and making sure they are in a good place. I've either get my Air Pods in or the music blasting, and I'm in my happy place with the horses."

It's something her father would no doubt be proud of.

"My dad got me started in this and the Nickerson family steamrolled everything forward for me," she said. "I've had great opportunities, but it's going back to those moments in Maine, when he would drive in the amateur races, to see his happiness, driving and training... to be along for that ride was amazing. It's those moments that keep you coming back every day."

Covered Bridge used a perfect covered trip to steamroll his way to victory in the \$150,000 Camluck Classic Invitational on Friday night (May 26) at The Raceway at The Western Fair District.

Driven by Jordan Stratton, who won the race in 2017 with Bit Of A Legend, Covered Bridge got away fourth in the early going as triple millionaire This Is The Plan insisted on the lead through a quick: 26.4 opening quarter with post 7 starter Idealsomemagic parked in the first-over position in the early stages.

Stratton was able to work his way out on the back of that parked-out rival and followed as long as he could before tipping three-wide at the three-quarter pole in 1:23.4. Covered Bridge

got up alongside This Is The Plan at the top of the stretch with Whichwaytothebeach in close pursuit along the inside and Roll With The Flow closing from the back of the pack.

Covered Bridge was able to draw clear in the stretch for a 1-1/4 length decision in 1:52 with This Is The Plan holding second and Roll With The Flow charging late to land the show spot.

The victory was the third straight and eighth this season in 17 starts for the gelded son of American Ideal who is owned by Mark Ford of Campbell Hall, NY and trained by Jeff Gillis. The payday vaulted the pacer to just shy of \$300,000 this season as he closes in on \$900,000 lifetime.

On the powerful Camluck undercard, Canada's pacing queen **So Much More** won a thrilling edition of the \$50,000 Forest City Pace for driver James MacDonald in 1:53, just a fifth off the track record for pacing mares.

The race was an action-packed affair from start to finish with So Frisky playing hardball early and parking out Raptors Won who had attempted to leave from post 3. So Much More, who sat just off the pace, was forced to go three-wide at the five-eighths and raced three-wide for much of the rest of the mile and was able to fend off Mystifying who was flying from the back of the pack to finish second.

The victory was the 64th lifetime one for the daughter of Big Jim who increased her career bankroll to almost \$1.4 million for owners Don and Ken Beatson, along with Cole England. It was redemption for So Much More who had a troubled trip in last year's edition of the race.

A large on-track crowd produced a total handle for the 12-race card just over \$850,000, a record wager for the Camluck Classic/Molson Pace program.

The Raceway has one more live program to end off the race season this Monday night (May 29) with first post at 5:50 p.m.

Take All Comers to take on Maxie Lee foes

Take All Comers will make his seasonal debut in today's (May 28) \$100,000 Maxie Lee Memorial Invitational for older trotters at Harrah's Philadelphia, and the 5-year-old gelding has already improved from last year in one regard. He will begin the race from a favorable starting point.

Last season, Take All Comers drew posts on the outer third of the starting gate, or in the second tier, in five of the eight most lucrative races he competed in. He missed hitting the board in all five. In his remaining 11 starts, he hit the board every time, winning eight.

Today, Take All Comers will leave from post one.

"That's a step forward," trainer Jim Campbell said with a laugh.

Take All Comers, who finished second in last season's Graduate Series final for 4-year-old trotters and ended his campaign on a three-race winning streak, heads to the Maxie Lee off a 1:54 qualifier victory on May 16 at Philly.

"He was really good qualifying," Campbell said. "This is a tough first start for any horse to make off one qualifier, in with that

caliber of horse, but there are no easy spots in racing today. You've got to get started somewhere, and he drew good, so hopefully he can pick up a good check from there."

Take All Comers has been adept at making money throughout his career, earning a paycheck in 32 of 38 career races. Lifetime, the homebred son of Creatine—Nantab has won 11 starts and earned \$559,171 for owner Runthetable Stables.

"He may not win, but he gives you an honest effort every time you put him out there," Campbell said. "You just love to have horses like him in the barn. He's got a good attitude and he's a fun horse to be around. He feels good; he's got some play in him. You take him out to train and it's like he knows where he's supposed to go. He's a real cool horse."

Take All Comers, who last year won six of his eight starts that came after mid-August, is not staked to many Grand Circuit events in the summer but will have the opportunity to test those waters later in the campaign if all goes well.

"He went longer last year [racing until late November] so we didn't bring him back until sometime in mid-to-late February," Campbell said. "We're going to race him along in overnights and he's staked to some races in the fall. He seems to like the fall. We're just kind of playing it by ear with him."

Today's Maxie Lee field of eight includes 2022 winner Lovedbythemasses. Also among the group is former Dan Patch Award winner Amigo Volo, who has earned more than \$2 million in his career.

The card at Philly also features the \$100,000 Joseph Auger Memorial Invitational for older male pacers and the \$100,000 Betsy Ross Invitational for older female pacers.

Hellabalou, the winner of the MGM Borgata Pacing Series final at Yonkers, is among the eight horses in the Auger Memorial, which is named after the longtime Philly race secretary who passed away last year.

In the Betsy Ross, Blue Chip Matchmaker Series champ Amazing Dream N is joined by former Dan Patch Award-winners Niki Hill and Treacherous Dragon in the octet.

Through the decades with David Miller

Thirty years ago, David Miller was the 1993 recipient of the U.S. Harness Writers Association's Rising Star Award.

Ten years later, he received his first Driver of the Year Award after guiding No Pan Intended to the Pacing Triple Crown and Horse of the Year honors.

A decade from there, he was elected to the Harness Racing Hall of Fame.

And now in 2023, Miller has become the sixth driver in history to reach 14,000 lifetime victories. To celebrate that accomplishment, the 58-year-old Miller recently took the time to look back at those landmark seasons that helped shape his career.



THE BREAKTHROUGH - 1993

Miller was a leading driver in Ohio prior to 1993, but he reached new heights that season. He won 480 races to finish fourth among all drivers in North America — his first time in the top five — and landed in the top 25 in purses for the first time, with \$2.13 million. He has not been outside the top 25 ever since and has ranked in the top five in 23 of the past 24 years (amassing \$272 million in purses to be No. 2 among drivers in history).

He also won his first race at The Meadowlands, capturing a division of the Niatross for 2-year-old male pacers by 11 lengths with Falcons Future in 1:52.3.

"That was huge," Miller said. "I'd been to The Meadowlands before, but I'd never driven in a race there. It was great. That was a huge feeling of accomplishment."

Thirty years later, does Miller remember details from the win?

"Oh, for sure; heck, yeah," Miller said. "I remember scoring down and I'm out there with John Campbell, Mike Lachance, Cat Manzi, Ron Waples — all of them. Falcons Future was one of the favorites. I got away third. At the quarter, I moved him to the front, and he just ran off. He was just so strong. I never really asked him to go. He was an amazing horse."

Falcons Future won eight of 11 races and finished second twice in 1993. His best performance came at Mohawk Raceway in

Ontario, where he won a division of the Nassagaweya Stakes by 13 lengths in a Canadian-record 1:51.3. The time was just two-fifths of a second off Artsplace's world record on a five-eighths-mile track.

"That's when people really took notice of him," Miller said. "He was a lot of fun. He was such a phenomenal horse."

Other highlights for Miller in 1993 included notching his 2,000th career triumph, which came at the Delaware County Fairgrounds in Ohio, and winning eight races on a single card at The Meadows, which equaled the word record.

CROWNING ACHIEVEMENT - 2003

No Pan Intended became the 10th pacer in history to win the Triple Crown, with Miller driving the 3-year-old to victories in the Cane Pace, Little Brown Jug, and Messenger to accomplish the feat. No pacer has won the Triple Crown since.

For the season, No Pan Intended won 17 of 21 races, finished second three times, and banked \$1.46 million. He finished fourth in the Meadowlands Pace on July 12, then reeled off 10 consecutive victories during his Triple Crown chase.

The first jewel in the Crown was the Cane Pace, which No Pan Intended won at Freehold Raceway.

Harness Racing Update

"I'll never forget [track announcer] Larry Lederman's call," Miller said. "Allamerican Native was the favorite in the race. At the head of the stretch, I'd gotten to him and was going by. Lederman said, 'He's on his way. He's the 2003 Cane Pace winner.'

"That was a very true statement because he was on his way. From there on, he was unbeatable. It was an amazing ride."

Seventeen days later, Miller and No Pan Intended won the Little Brown Jug in straight heats at the Delaware County Fairgrounds in Ohio. No Pan Intended won the final in gate-to-wire fashion, beating Make It Brief by a length. For Miller, an Ohio native, it was the win of a lifetime.

"It's very hard to keep my composure," he said after the race. "I had no intention of letting anybody go. This is a dream come true. I've been dreaming about this my whole life."

The Jug win was one of 10 victories by Miller that day, which remains the track record at Delaware.

"Honestly, if I wouldn't have won the Jug, it would have been just an ordinary day," Miller said at the time.

After a Tattersalls Pace triumph, No Pan Intended completed the Crown quest by winning both his elimination and final of the Messenger at The Meadows. The colt drew post eight for the final but started from post seven because of a scratch. Once again, he won gate-to-wire, besting The Globe by 1-1/2 lengths.

"I remember standing in the paddock, and I was nervous. There was a lot on the line," Miller said. "But once we got on the track, I had a lot of confidence in him and it all went away. It was a pretty cool moment."

No Pan Intended capped his year — and career — with a victory by a head over Escape The Wind in the Breeders Crown at The Meadowlands.

"In the winner's circle it was [owner] Bob Glazer, me, and [trainer] Ivan Sugg. I told them, 'Let's hold the trophy up for the Horse of the Year. And he ended up being Horse of the Year. It was unbelievable."

HALL CALL - 2013

Three years before getting notified he was elected to the national Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 2013, Miller was enshrined in Ohio's Hall of Fame.

"When I got the call, I was really cool about it," Miller said of the Ohio honor. "Then I went to the banquet and got up on stage and all I did was cry. It was pretty moving."

So, the second time around, Miller readily soaked up the significance of the moment.

"The biggest honor you can receive in your profession, I think, is for people to think of you that way," Miller said prior to his induction. "To be put in the Hall of Fame with people that I looked up to, it's very special. I feel privileged."

Reflecting on the Hall call today, time has not diminished the emotions.

"It was a feeling of accomplishment," said Miller, whose induction ceremony at the Hall of Fame in Goshen, NY, came in July 2014.

"John Campbell was there, and he said the only reason he and [his wife] Paula came was to watch me go in. It's like a fairytale almost. He's my idol, and he's telling me this. It was a very proud moment. Don't let anyone tell you it didn't mean anything to them because it's a moment when your peers are looking up to you. It's awesome. It's surreal."

Of course, Miller's election to the Hall of Fame was not the end of his story. In the years since, he's added two Driver of the Year honors, driven two more Horse of the Year winners (Always B Miki and Test Of Faith), collected 16 more Breeders Crown trophies — including a record five in 2015 — to up his total to 30, and won more than 3,000 races.

Which bring us to...

14,000 AND STILL COUNTING

Miller got his 14,000th win this past Friday (May 19) when he drove Island Of The Sea to victory at Harrah's Philadelphia. It was a moment of joy... and relief. The triumph proved to be elusive, with Miller getting the win after two days of trying.

"People kept asking about it, there was a lot of anticipation, and it got to where I just wanted it over with," Miller said. "I'm out there and I'm trying my hardest to win a race. I was trying really hard. But you do your best work when you're not thinking about it. It will happen when it happens.

"After I lost the first race on Friday, I told myself not to worry about it. If it takes two weeks, it's going to happen. When I was coming through the stretch with [Island Of The Sea], I was like thank God. We got it."

Even if it was a frustrating stretch, Miller maintained his sense of humor. He had six second-place finishes during the two days, including by a head and a nose to horses driven by Tim Tetrick.

"I told him, I don't want you in my picture anyway," Miller said with a laugh. "I just want to be in the picture all by myself."

What did it mean to reach the milestone?

"I'm proud of it," Miller said. "It didn't really sink in until I saw the number '14,000.' Then, you're like, wow. It's a good feeling. I've been very fortunate."

Now, Miller is focused on his future in the sport, which he hopes will continue for another number of decades.

"I saw a guy won a race recently at 80-something years old," Miller said, adding with a laugh, "Heck, I've got 30 years left in me. I'll do it until they say, listen, we don't think you should be out there. I enjoy racing. As long as I'm capable of doing it, I love to do it."

Gabe Prewitt has joined the Red Mile as vice president of racing and sports wagering operations.

Prewitt was formerly director of racing with Caesars Entertainment, overseeing racing operations at five properties while primarily based at Pompano Park, in Pompano Beach, FL. Earlier this month, Caesars Entertainment announced an agreement with Keeneland/Red Mile to open central Kentucky's only brick-and-mortar retail sportsbook locations, subject to regulatory approvals from the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission.

Prewitt has been a part of the broadcast team on many of harness racing's biggest days, including national broadcasts featured on CBS Sports, FS1, FS2 and SNY networks. He has also served as track announcer at several venues, including the Red Mile since 2007.

Another Like Me raced in the pocket behind 7-2 second choice A Good Chardonnay before ripping out of that spot on the far turn on the way to an easy 1¼-length win in a lifetime-best 1:54. Baby Take A Vow was second with The Empress Ice third.

As the 4-5 favorite, Another Like Me, who's now two-for-four in her career, returned \$3.80 to win with Yannick Gingras doing the driving.

"The Hambletonian Oaks?" Takter said. "It's definitely a spot where you might see her. But she is playing catch up a bit."

FERRARI FABULOUS: After failing at odds of 1-5 and 1-2, respectively, in his last two starts, **Ari Ferrari J** still had the confidence of the betting public in a non-winners of two for trotters, scoring as the 1-20 public choice in a lifetime-best 1:53.4.

"He's a big strong horse who's easy to drive," said winning pilot Gingras. "This was a good prep for next week's [New Jersey] Sire Stakes final."

Ari Ferrari J, a 3-year-old colt by Walner—Dream Child who raced on the Grand Circuit all year long during 2022, lifted his lifetime earnings past the \$240,000 mark while recording his second win from 16 lifetime outings for trainer Tony Alagna.

A LITTLE MORE: Gingras and Dave Miller led the driver colony with three winners apiece on the night. Alagna was the top trainer with three walks down victory lane. All-source wagering on the 13-race card totaled \$2,257,753.

What action did the judges take in questionable Big M race

RE: The Meadowlands was correct in handling of race investigation

Jeff [Gural] and Jason [Settlemoir] both get "ataboys" as the implementation of the Big M's right of exclusion and subsequent suspension pending their investigation once again protects punters as well as their business interest.

My question is what action did the judges take as this race crossed the wire? The trio certainly must have been aware of the poor performance of the favorite. They have the advantage of viewing the prices before they make it official. The questionable payoffs should not be the sole reason to investigate a race but should serve as an additional incentive to investigate.

In addition to reviewing the replay there are additional steps the judges can take before posting the official. Was the mutuel manager called to request a cursory review of possible suspicious wagers? Did the presiding judge request a printout? You might think with wagers placed at off track sites it would be difficult to acquire this data in a timely fashion. It can be available before the evening's races are complete. After the race review and official were the drivers involved called inquiring about their horses' performance? Was the favorite checked by the state vet post-race and was blood and urine samples acquired from the beaten favorite?


Jason's action may or may not have precluded any investigation initiated by the judges but certainly was effective in protecting the wagering public.
