Joe Faraldo: Don't panic over Yonkers being sold to MGM

The president of the Standardbred Owners Association of New York said racing is locked up at the track through 2019 and the new operator may even help to grow purses.

Joe Faraldo said there is no reason, yet, to be concerned about racing's future at Yonkers Raceway in the wake of Tuesday's announcement that the Rooney family has reached a deal to sell the Westchester, NY track and its Empire City Casino to MGM Resorts International for \$850 million.

Reached in France, where he is part of the team scouting French trotters to purchase and bring back to the United States, Faraldo, the president of the Standardbred Owners Association of New York (SOANY) said the horsepeople have a contract with Yonkers that provides for more than 230 days of racing annually through 2019.

"We expect that will continue to be the case past its 2019

expiration date, as will the purse enhancement from the VLTs. Racing and VLTs are also married in (New York state) legislation for the benefit of the operator as well as the agriculture and racing industry's tens of thousands of jobs."

Faraldo added that MGM Grand may even help grow purses thanks to its business acumen in the casino business.

"Slots contribute, by far, the vast amount of the revenue stream for every casino operator and MGM Grand is one of

the best operators I know of," Faraldo said, indicating a growth in slot/VLT revenue would deliver more money to purses.

An article on USA Today-affiliated lohud.com ([full story here](#)) written by Matt Coyne indicated the 119-year-old horse track and casino – which has been owned for nearly 50 years by the same Rooney family that owns the NFL's Pittsburgh Steelers – called the deal "huge news for the southeast Yonkers business that... finds itself having to fight for relevancy against competition further upstate and in Connecticut and New Jersey."

The story said the, "deal includes MGM refinancing Empire City's outstanding \$245 million debt. MGM Growth Properties will technically be purchasing the property for about \$625 million, including the refinanced debt."

With Yonkers located just 15 miles from Times Square in Manhattan, MGM chairman and CEO Jim Murren has talked about the deal's potential for his company to expand into the "high-density New York City region," but few details are yet available about what MGM plans to do with the 97-acre site that boasts the sixth largest gaming floor in the country with 5,222 VLTs. Though video blackjack was added to Yonkers in 2015, the gaming facility does not have table games.

"MGM will likely have to do something as the fight for bettors' dollars increases," Coyne wrote. "Resorts World Catskills in Sullivan County offers live table games, while its sibling, Resorts World Casino in Queens, offers similar fare to Empire City. Those two only add to the traditional competition in Atlantic City and eastern Connecticut, plus new casinos in eastern Pennsylvania."

MGM has also been mum, so far, about its plans for horse racing on Yonkers' half-mile oval.

"There certainly may be changes but until we sit down with the new people for future terms and conditions governing the conduct of racing, there is no need to engage in wild speculation or make further comments at this time," Faraldo said. "Suffice it to say that the SOA of NY's long standing position regarding the protection of racing and agriculture is well known... We look forward to working with the new management after the official approval is given by the NYS Gaming Commission."

The SOANY also released a statement congratulating Tim Rooney Sr. and the entire Rooney family on the sale of the facility.

"We have known this day would eventually be upon us and wish to thank the Rooneys for a nearly 50-year partnership that has seen tremendous growth in the New York horse racing industry," said the statement. "Our agreements insure that racing will continue through this contract and those to come. The jobs in horse racing and agriculture are important to the New York State economy and we are confident that new management recognizes this."

Coyne's article said "the deal is expected to close in the first quarter of 2019, because the state Gaming Commission needs to review the sale and license MGM to run the facility."

The Lexington Selected Sales Co. announced today that the company will launch a new mixed sale this fall in Lexington, KY. The sale will be held on Sunday evening, Oct. 7 at the Fasig-Tipton sales grounds. It will follow an afternoon of racing at Red Mile that features the Kentucky Futurity and Tattersalls Pace, and will come at the conclusion of the selected yearling sale held the previous five days.

“The principals of Red Mile – Winbak Farm’s Joe Thomson, Brittany’s George Segal, and Lindy’s Frank Antonacci – along with the owners of Kentuckiana Farms, are all committed to strongly supporting the sale,” said Lexington Selected co-manager David Reid.

“The new sale will further enhance what we call ‘the Lexington experience,’” co-manager Randy Manges added. “Its revenues will be directed toward improving the purse structure at Red Mile and perhaps one day, creating new stakes events.”

Reid also said the mixed sale hopes to capitalize on the diverse, international crowd that will already be in Lexington for racing and the yearling sale.

“We’ll have the buyers in town, and we have use of one of the world’s greatest horse sale facilities. But what makes it even more appealing is that sellers will have the opportunity to showcase their racehorses prior to the sale in stakes races, late closers and overnights at Red Mile the previous two weeks. It’s a natural,” he said.

According to Reid, the sale will focus not only on attracting

racehorses of all ages, but also in-foal mares and race fillies – “the kind of fillies with pedigree and pizzazz that light up a bid board.”

The best driver, improving racing broadcasts and why Vernon Downs was so fast

Editorial: Talk about the Wild West. It just moved a little further east. A well-known barn raced a very short-priced claiming horse recently. The horse was odds on and won easily. I see the horse was claimed by one of the stable's premier owners, obviously with a different trainer. Subsequently, the horse was raced back and reclaimed by the original barn. There is probably nothing illegal about this transaction, however it is certainly unethical and as a judge I personally would have voided the claim. Thinking about this I am wondering if the race office or judges realized how unscrupulous this kind of maneuvering actually was.

When the Big M returns to greatness shortly, we will see fantastic racing without any of this nonsense. The sad thing is the barn in question makes millions. How greedy can you be to do something this dumb for a few thousand dollars? I am no purest, but I was so annoyed I had to print this.

Bob Carlson from Ontario asks: Who is the best harness driver in the world today and why?

Unfortunately, I have little awareness of the best of the Down Under or European drivers so I will stick to North America and say unequivocally, in my less than humble opinion, that Yannick Gingras is the best that you can have today. I believe that a great amount of the success of Jimmy Takter and Ronnie Burke are the Yannick Factor. Remember, when he drives for them, the rest of the field is missing the "It Factor" so even when the big stable has a horse that's less than the favorite, the best driver is removed from the mix. I am definitely prejudiced when it come to Yannick because in the waning years of my career his win percentage for me was at some ridiculous level. I find, even to this day, he has the ability to communicate that many drivers severely lack. A trainer wants the truth plain and not sugar coated, and that's what he delivers. He always answers texts and has a plan for his week and for the most part knows where he will be on a given day. Another thing I found was that if you have the best horse and Ron or Jim are in with you he will invariably

drive your horse.

I get tired of hearing that anyone who had his clients would look great. I totally disagree there are many others that drive for Takter and Burke and few do nearly as well.

Don't get me wrong there are many great drivers, but you asked for one and he happens to come from Canada, too.

Of note, the Hambletonian trophy that has thus far avoided Yannick's grasp will be in his hands on the first Saturday in August, the Guru predicts.

Billy Bigler asks: You asked on Facebook for a website to see the Elitloppet and I sent you one did you get to enjoy it?

Absolutely, and thanks so much. After seeing the production I was amazed what a fabulous job they did and I don't even speak Swedish.

Hearty congratulations to two of my really good friends, Jerry (the prince of Providence) Riordan, and Wim Paal the famous German driver that delivered their great win in the 2018 Elitloppet with Ringostarr Treb. In the first heat, Wim protected the rail and let one horse go on the way to the quarter where he immediately retook the lead, slowed the pace to a walk and sprinted home for an easy victory.

The second heat, however, was no walk in the park as the competition was far more difficult. Ringostarr Treb went to post the second choice behind the Elizabeth Caldwell-bred Propulsion. Trained by Daniel Reden, a baby faced young man that has talented beyond his years, Propulsion made a great race of it with a furious late charge falling a bit short. I personally don't think Propulsion looked very comfortable in the last turn and had trouble closing the gap. He was forced to go very wide coming into the stretch, leaving too much track between him and Ringostarr Treb and not enough time to get there. But I don't want to take a thing away from the winner. The preparation was perfect as were both drives. The horse was very strong in a very fast mile.

Jerry and I have been friends since we both trained for Lou Guida and when Jerry moved to Italy he was very helpful keeping the peace between me and Lou, which wasn't always so easy. Interesting that I first met Wim Paal when he won the Lotteria for Jerry and Guida with Embassy Lobell in 1993.



His longtime girlfriend Alesandra Baldi is Lorenzo Baldi's sister and Lorenzo won the Orsi Mangelli in San Siro, Milan for me with Trustworthy. What a small world. Wim and I became close and he spent a while in the U.S. and trained and drove some of my horses. I think he returned to the European circuit because on the continent a driver is a Rock Star. Not so much in the U.S.

Many American trainers have raced in Europe, few have stayed and certainly none as long as Jerry. It takes a special person to change his and his family's lives to that extent. But it certainly is a possibility for a young man or woman to consider today. The lifestyle is amazing. The crowds, like the 60,000 at the Elitloppet are a weekly, not yearly, occurrence and the betting is over the top compared to the U.S. However, America is a very special place and is not so easy to leave.

Richard Herman asks: I know both you and your buddy Art Zubrod have been critical of various television productions of horse racing. What could we do in our sport to improve the shows?

I watch most of my harness racing on my computer attached to a large screen smart TV. I find the picture pretty good most of the time, and you get full volume through your television. I can't stand watching TVG do harness racing. To me it's embarrassing how they can't pronounce the names of world class horses or drivers. This is a display of not caring or basic laziness or both on their part and it infuriates me. The worst is when they put a \$300,000 harness race on tape delay to show the finest \$5,000 claiming race from Los Alamitos and then take another five minutes to explain how the jockey on the favorite did the wrong thing.

My new pet peeve came this weekend watching the great Memorial Day Sunday card from Harrah's Philadelphia when the announcer in between each of the earlier races would say there goes Hannelore Hanover going by in her warm up, there goes Filibuster Hanover etc.etc. What the hell? I am sitting home looking at an odds board on my screen and this guy is telling me what's going on, on the track not even saying the horse looks good or bad. Why not show the picture of the warm ups. We still are a gambling sport. If you have time to editorialize what you are seeing on the track why not show the customer, it might just improve the handle. Now if there is some kind of rule against this that I am not aware of I apologize but as of this writing I know no such provision.

As a matter of fact, I think showing warm ups would be a major change for the better and the bettor. Eliminate replays. If necessary, you can show them any time and they are available 24/7. Both the Meadowlands and Red Mile have interviews with trainers, drivers and owners before and after the races. I am sure this increases confidence in many gamblers as well as making the production very entertaining.

Nothing will ever replicate Sam McKee's great work at the

Jug and the Red Mile, which was so enjoyable it could make a 20-race Jug card all day fun.

It would also help to have one handicapper to give multi-race picks for Pick 3, 4, and 5's.

We must also end the drag time before post. That is the time between the listed post time and the actual start of the race. Some tracks are bigger offenders than others, but the closer to perfect we get the more pleasurable experience it would be for the viewers.

I love the crowds attracted to the replica bands at Pocono Downs. I am sure they help the handle and they put on a wonderful show between races. If any tracks still care about on track handle this would be another avenue of consideration. I realize that this was off the beaten path from the original question, but please consider it writer's privilege.

David Elliot asks: I have seen fast racetracks in my life but why was it so ridiculously fast at Vernon Monday afternoon?

I watched all the races and was surprised at the speed myself. The 1:50.3 mile of Atlanta pulling away from another very good filly in Plunge Blue Chip was more than impressive.

To properly answer your question, I called a few of the drivers and the general consensus was that it was a perfect day hot, in the 80's no wind and track condition was excellent. Most felt that the track was always one and a half or two seconds faster than the Meadowlands so it was like the perfect storm, very much like the evening race 25 years ago when Beat the Wheel won in 1:51.3 at the Big M.

This does set up a great scenario that has been discussed all winter at Sunshine Meadows. Manchego vs. Atlanta, a great story, that may possibly not even happen on the first Saturday in August. What happens if one goes in the open and the other races in the Oaks? KEEP TUNED.

I have had many of you asking about the Hambletonian eligibles and what the picture looks like. I still favor Wolfgang and Manchego and not because I trained and loved both dams but because of their performance on the track. Now we throw Atlanta in the mix and it starts to get very interesting. As soon as some others start hitting the track I will be answering those queries.

Sophomores come out with guns blazing

If you blinked, you may have missed that this year's stakes season has gone from 0 to 60 in about two weeks.

Some of the best horses from last season's 2-year-old group are still making their way back to the track for their upcoming year, but already there have been a number of rising stars that have given many of the top contenders in their divisions something to think about.

Without question, the story of the early stakes season thus far has been the filly trotter, Atlanta. Trained by Rick Zeron, the daughter of Chapter Seven—Hemi Blue Chip has been nothing less than monstrous in her three starts this year. In her most recent race this past Memorial Day from Vernon, she trotted her winning mile in 1:50:3.

In doing so, she became the third fastest filly trotter in the history of the sport only a tick off Mission Brief and Cee Bee Yes. In fact, the only male horses ahead of her include Donato Hanover, Muscle Hill, Father Patrick, Tom Ridge and Walner. That's some rarified company to be in. None of those horses ever accomplished a time that fast while still in the month of May.

What's most impressive is that if her and the 2-year-old champion Manchego raced today, Atlanta would most likely be favored. Of all the rivalries to look forward to this year, an Atlanta-Manchego showdown would be most highly anticipated one right now.

Outside of those two filly trotters, the only other 3-year-old that appears on the first Hambletonian/USTA Top Ten poll of the year is Trump Nation.

Trump Nation exits a fast 1:51:3 in the Rooney at Yonkers last week where he humbled the heavily-backed Allard entrant, Springsteen. The win for Trump Nation came on the heels of a barn change from Andrew Harris to Chris Oakes, and this one improved two full seconds from his elimination

win a week prior. In his new surroundings, he could be a force throughout the season.

As expected, the 3-year-old pacing group coming out of PA is unbelievably strong. The top 2-year-olds last year Lost In Time and Stay Hungry debuted for the season two weeks ago in a PASS race at Pocono along with standouts Nutcracker Sweet and Hayden Hanover, but all were defeated by a colt named Wes Delight. Now 4-for-5 on the year, Wes Delight followed up that PASS win with a win earlier this week against another star from last year, This Is The Plan.

On that same card from Monday, Done Well returned from a season-ending injury last year for Brian Brown to beat I'm A Big Deal in a PA All Star race to remain unbeaten in his career in five starts. Winning the remaining All Star division that night was Dorsoduro Hanover who was equally impressive in 1:50:3 over top competition; both him and Done Well are North American Cup eligible.

Moving to New York, Vernon's Memorial Day card produced some exceptionally fast times all day. Included in the 1:50:3 Atlanta clocking was a 1:51:2 on the colt side of the Empire Breeders Classic won by Six Pack. Though knocking on the door of the top 10 in the current USTA poll, it's hard to gauge where Six Pack will stand once the majority of last year's colt trotters make their way back onto the track.

But it could be horses from two of the NYSS divisions that day for pacers that produces horses worth watching in the upcoming North America Cup. Courtly Choice was a 1:48:4 winner that day for trainer Blake Macintosh and that time makes him the fastest 3-year-old right now in the sport. A perfect 2-for-2 on the year, he is Cup eligible as is American History who won the race immediately afterwards in 1:49:1 for trainer Tony Alagna.

As the 3-year-old pacing picture begins to take shape, one to watch could be the I'm Gorgeous colt Lather Up. Trained by Clyde Francis and driven by Montrell Teague this one has been instilled as the 4-5 favorite in his division of the Somebeachsomewhere at Woodbine Mohawk this Saturday. He'll get tested perhaps, but comes off a 7-length romp most recently in 1:49:1 when debuting locally in Canada.

Last year's Breeders Crown runner-up Shnitzledosomethin made a successful return to the races last week in Indiana-sired competition and races there again this weekend. Another that is Cup eligible, he could be an underrated type coming out of the Midwest.

If the introduction this past month to stakes season is any indication of things to come, we should be in for a wild ride between now and the fall Breeders Crown.

Battle of Lake Erie preview

Rockin Ron comes off a track record performance in the freshly-coined Camluck Classic at Western Fair last week and will be the heaviest of favorites to come right back and win the Battle of Lake Erie. He set a track record in that race when he won in 1:50:1 over the historically slow track and with no one in the vicinity of him that night, can anyone get close now?

Missile J hasn't started since April 21 although he had some success in the Levy at Yonkers and lands the best post of any realistic contender. Bit Of A Legend N couldn't get close to Rockin Ron at Western Fair and you wonder what the strategy will be now. Does Stratton have anything to lose by leaving with his horse that typically closes? All Bets Off is another that hasn't race since 4/21 and the iron tough horse now has something to prove again.

This isn't the best race for betting purposes as Rockin Ron should be able to secure an easy lead with a completely overmatched horse starting to his inside. It could be over from the start, and I'd include Missile J for second to complete a short priced exacta.

Foiled Again watch

Foiled Again is no stranger to the Battle of Lake Erie wars and it would be fitting if he picked up career win #100 on the undercard.

Racing in a N/W \$3,500 conditioned event carded as race 8, he makes his second start back following an acclimating effort last out at the Meadowlands. This is a monster drop following that race won by Blood Line and driver Kakaley fresh back from injury gets the call to try to steer the milestone win.

The main threat could come from Alpin Hanover who has been putting up some relatively fast miles on paper here at Northfield of late. The \$20,000 claimer is capable of speed

and is going right to the front for Merriman; we'll see if he wants to mix it up with all with Foiled Again. Man He Can Skoot used to be pretty fast and does come off a win from post 8, but it came in 1:55:2 in the off-going with a final quarter of just :30:2.

Even with the bad post, this should be the spot where we see Foiled Again pick up win number 100.

No mistake: Lather Up wows connections

Ask owner Gary Iles about his 3-year-old male pacer Lather Up and he will tell you, "He's got quite a story, no doubt about it." The story, which includes a tricky birth and near-fatal illness, begins with a mistake. How it ends is anyone's guess, but the tale has taken another compelling turn with Lather Up a perfect 3-for-3 in 2018 as he prepares for Saturday's Somebeachsomewhere Stakes at Woodbine Mohawk Park and a trip to the North America Cup.

Iles and his wife Barbara are longtime horse owners from Delaware. The couple is known for their homebred horses, which usually feature a name referencing Iles' former career as a barber.

Lather Up is a son of stallion I'm Gorgeous out of the Iles' homebred mare Pocket Comb. But the Iles intended to breed Pocket Comb to stallion Delmarvalous. A mix up when ordering semen resulted in the now-seemingly serendipitous change of plans, which hinged on Iles' admiration for I'm Gorgeous' sire Bettor's Delight.

"I really always liked Bettor's Delight and always wanted to breed to him, I just didn't do it," the 79-year-old Iles said. "So that's how we ended up with I'm Gorgeous."

When it came time for Lather Up's birth, there was a complication. Lather Up was in the breech position, which required action from local horsemen Kevin Switzer and Brenda Teague. The two worked together while receiving phoned-in instructions from Switzer's wife, veterinarian Denise McNitt, to prevent a breech birth.

Once on the racetrack last year at age 2, Lather Up won three times on the Ohio Sire Stakes circuit, but got sick as he was preparing for the series championship. He suffered a near-fatal reaction to antibiotics, which landed the horse in the New Bolton Center.

"He really got off to a rocky start," Iles said. "We came very close to losing him. We got lucky; very, very lucky."

Now, though, Lather Up's story involves winning races. The colt, from the Team Teague training stable of George Teague Jr., Brenda Teague and Clyde Francis, made his seasonal debut by beating older horses at Harrah's Philadelphia before a track-record 1:50 win in a division of the Ohio Sire Stakes at Miami Valley Raceway. The win at Miami Valley came on a sloppy track following a lengthy delay because of thunderstorms.

Last weekend at Woodbine Mohawk Park, Lather Up prepped for his upcoming stakes engagements by winning in 1:49.1 against older foes. Leaving from post nine, the colt and driver Montrell Teague reached the lead in a :26.1 opening quarter-mile and never looked back, winning by

7-3/4 lengths with a :26.2 final quarter-mile.

"He put in a heck of a mile," Iles said.

"He wowed me," George Teague Jr. said. "I was a little bit surprised, I'm not going to lie to you, with how he did it. Montrell never popped the ear plugs."

Lather Up always showed promise, but steering issues sometimes prevented the colt from peak performance. Teague thinks those issues have been resolved.

"He's much better now," Teague said. "I'm happy with that part. He seems to be controllable and very steerable. We made a couple equipment changes and got lucky and hit the target."

"We always thought he could be this kind of horse if everything went right, but it hasn't always gone right for him. He's a very smart horse, very good gaited. He's got the tools to do some damage in the 3-year-old ranks. He just needs a little luck and to stay sound and healthy."

On Saturday, Lather Up competes in the second of three **Somebeachsomewhere Stakes divisions at Woodbine Mohawk Park**. If all goes well, a trip to the Pepsi North America Cup eliminations will follow on June 9 at Mohawk. The C\$1 million final is June 16.

"We're excited," said Iles, who lost his broodmare Pocket Comb -- the producer of eight six-figure earners in 10 foals -- last year at the age of 23. Lather Up was her final offspring.

"I'm anxious to see how he does. He's shown a lot of guts and I hope he can continue."

And so the story continues.

"To say the least," Teague said with a laugh, "it's been very interesting."



Somebeachsomewhere and Graduate set for Saturday at Woodbine Mohawk Park

A stakes-filled card with major Pepsi North America Cup implications is set for this Saturday evening (June 2) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Somebeachsomewhere Stakes and Graduate Series will make up half of Saturday's card with three divisions of each event to be contested.

A big turnout for the Somebeachsomewhere Stakes has 28 three-year-old pacers split into three \$60,000 divisions. The event for sophomores is annually slated for the week prior to the Pepsi North America Cup eliminations and this year's event will see 19 eligible pacers prepping for Canada's richest harness race.

Metro Pace champion Lost In Time headlines this year's edition, as the Dan Patch Award winner will leave from post-three with driver Scott Zeron in Saturday's third division.

A son of A Rocknroll Dance—Summer Mystery, Lost In Time will be making his second start of the season after finishing second by a nose in a Pennsylvania Sires Stakes division on May 19 at Pocono. The Jimmy Takter trainee has five wins, three runner-up finishes and over \$700,000 earned in 10 career starts.

Saturday's event will be Lost In Time's first start at Woodbine Mohawk Park since he captured the \$816,000 Metro Pace last September for original trainer Jim Mulinix.

Takter's stable will have a big chance to find the winner's circle in the evening's first division, as he sends out the strong duo of Grand Teton (PP2, Yannick Gingras) and Nutcracker Sweet (PP7, Tim Tetrick).

Nutcracker Sweet finished fourth in his season debut at Pocono on May 19 after posting a sizzling qualifying mile of 1:50.2 a week earlier at The Meadowlands. The son of Bettors Delight—Sweet Future won four of 13 starts, including two Grand Circuit events at Red Mile, during his rookie campaign.

Grand Teton, a half-brother to three-time Breeders Crown champion Pure Country, will be making his Canadian debut in the Somebeachsomewhere. The son of A Rocknroll Dance—Western Montana posted five wins and three runner-up finishes in 12 starts last season. He comes into Saturday's contest off a second-place finish at Pocono on May 19.

Local speedster Summer Travel (PP10, Louis Philippe Roy) will also compete in the opening-division and enters off a strong 1:50.3 win last week at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The evening's second division will have all eyes on Clyde Francis trainee Lather Up (PP5, Montrell Teague) following his ultra-impressive 1:49.1 victory last Saturday at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Lather Up is three for three this season after winning four of seven starts during an interrupted rookie campaign. The son of Ohio-stallion Im Gorgeous—Pocket Comb has posted track record miles in both his two and three-year-old seasons in the Buckeye State with a 1:51.1 performance last year at Scioto and a 1:50 effort on May 6 at Miami Valley.

The Somebeachsomewhere Stakes have been carded as Races 5, 8 and 10.

Woodbine Mohawk Park will also be hosting a leg of The Graduate Series on Saturday evening. The series for four-year-old pacers and trotters will be visiting the Milton, ON racetrack for the third-consecutive year.

The Graduate pacing division has attracted 16 entrants, split into two \$60,000 divisions, while the trotting side will see one-dash with an overflow field of 12 battling for \$95,250.

The opening-split for pacers includes Classic Pro (PP3, Sylvain Filion), last season's O'Brien Award winner, and Miso Fast (PP8, Tetrick), a career-winner of over \$600,000.

The second-division will see the Graduate Series debut of Beckhams Z Tam (PP3, Ricky Macomber Jr), who captured last year's Breeders Crown at Hoosier Park and is a career-winner of more than \$565,000.

The Graduate Trot has potential "race of the night" written all over it with a field of 12 to tango.

Superstar Ariana G (PP2, Gingras) is undefeated in six-career starts at Woodbine Mohawk Park and comes into Saturday's race off a victory in the first-leg on May 19 at The Meadowlands.

Achille Duharas (PP7, Mario Baillargeon) captured the other division on May 19 and is six for nine this season with four wins at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Graduate Series pacing splits have been carded as Races 3 and 9, while the trotting event will go as Race 7.

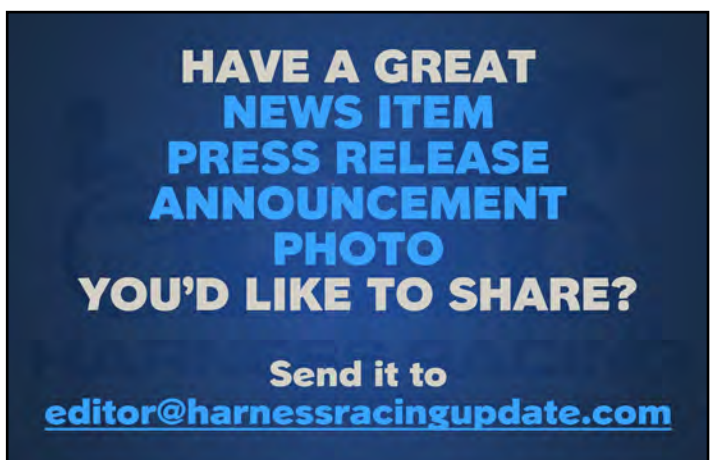

Harness writer, horse owner Ralph Sucee dead at 63

Standardbred Canada has reported that longtime standardbred industry participant Ralph Sucee died peacefully on Saturday (May 26), with family by his side at Lakeridge Health Oshawa, at the age of 63.

Sucee was a successful journalist in the harness racing community contributing articles for decades to publications such as The Canadian Sportsman, TROT Magazine and Hoof Beats Magazine.

An owner of standardbreds as well, most notably and recently the speedy pacer Pierce Hanover, Sucee found himself as the focus of numerous articles after surviving a near-fatal automotive accident in 2007 when the metal tongue of a dislodged utility trailer ripped through his windshield and across his upper body. Sucee suffered a multitude of broken bones on his left side, bruising on his brain, and damaged vertebrae in the lower part of his core due to the force of the injury to his left arm, which caused severe nerve damage.

Undeterred, Sucee was one of the first to come to the aid of injured horseman Kurt Hughes one year later when Hughes was involved in an accident of his own that left the up-and-coming horseman confined to a wheelchair. Sucee helped spearhead an online auction that raised more than \$61,000 for the Hughes family.

Sucee was also integrally involved as one of the principals in the Cyber Stable, one of the internet's first fractional ownership partnerships in the late 1990s and early 2000s.

Outside of the harness racing industry, Sucee found his true calling in social work, and his accomplishments with the

Children's Aid Society made a difference in the lives of many. A talented musician, singer and songwriter, Ralph's album will let his voice live on.

Loving father of Adam, Alana and Angela. Beloved son of Ron and Trudy. Cherished brother of Ken, Rob and Nancy, predeceased by twin brother Michael. Husband of Victoria for 25 years. Ralph will be dearly remembered by all of his extended family and friends.

Grismore grew up in Pandora, OH, and started in the business as a young teenager working with his father, Mark. He has driven at many racetracks throughout his illustrious career including stints at tracks on the East Coast. Grismore scored his first driving victory in 1987 and to date, 2007 was his winningest season with just over \$5 million in earnings. He is second in all-time victories at Northfield Park, behind only Aaron Merriman. Grismore's biggest scores include victories in the Cleveland Classic (Won The West, 2007) and the Jugette (Good News Lady, 2008).

Carryover at almost \$250,000 for Big M's Jackpot Super High-Five

Harness racing's biggest carryover has been building for some time now, and when patient players wait around for the 10th and final race tonight at the Meadowlands, they'll have the opportunity to take down almost a quarter-of-a-million dollars in the track's Late 20-Cent Jackpot Super High-Five.

The wager, which has a low 15 percent takeout, sports an exact carryover of \$240,774. For one to rake the entire pot, they must be the only player holding a ticket with the winning combination once the result is declared official. If there are multiple winning tickets, those players share 75 percent of the pool, with the remaining 25 per cent added to the existing carryover for the next time the wager is offered.

From the not-so-surprising files is the fact that the track's signature wager, the Pick-4, was the most popular in terms of play during May. During the month, the average total pool was \$90,699. The Pick-4 is a wager with a 50-cent base and a low 15 per cent takeout.

55 remain eligible to Pepsi North America Cup

The Pepsi North America Cup is nearly here and a total of 55 three-year-old pacers are eligible to be entered in the eliminations scheduled for Saturday, June 9 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The final sustaining payment for Canada’s richest harness race was due May 15 and payments for 55 of the previously 70 eligible sophomores were submitted.

This year’s Pepsi North America Cup originally attracted 90 nominations on February 15.

Award-winners Lost In Time and Stay Hungry remain eligible after being the pre-season favourites following outstanding rookie campaigns.

The list of 55 also includes Courtly Choice, who is currently the fastest three-year-old in North America following a 1:48.4 victory Monday at Vernon Downs, and Lather Up, who was a dominant winner last Saturday at Woodbine Mohawk Park in 1:49.1.

Many of the eligible three-year-old pacers will get one final start in preparation for the eliminations in this Saturday’s (June 2) Somebeachsomewhere Stakes at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Each elimination on June 9 will go for a purse of \$50,000 and the top finishers will advance to the \$1 million final on Saturday, June 16.
