Season of hope shifts to potential as babies hit the track

The earliest 2-year-olds have begun to emerge at tracks across North America.

After months of training down, it's that time of year where 2-year-olds start to make their public debuts on the racetrack. To this point, trainers may have a sense for what type of young horse that they have on their hands, but they haven't really known for sure. Competition in the form of qualifying races against horses from other barns is where the rubber begins to meet the road.

Adding to the anticipation are the 2-year-olds that reflect a new sires first crop. For this year, former foals now of racing age from highly-touted trotting sires Greenshoe and Six Pack, and Captain Crunch on the pacing side. As these 2-year-olds hit the track in the coming weeks it'll still be way too premature to pass any judgement on the success of their sires, but even the earliest indications of things to come can be of interest.

This past week, 2-year-old qualifiers have gotten underway in Ohio, Pennsylvania and Ontario. Action is starting in New Jersey as well, with baby races at The Meadowlands yesterday (Saturday) and another slate of 2-year-old races on tap tomorrow (Monday) at Gaitway Farm.

Some notables thus far in the super early going include a horse named **Four Sixes**, the first ever (qualifying) winner by Six Pack. A winner in 2:02 last week at The Meadows, Four Sixes was a \$30,000 yearling buy from the Lexington Selected Sale last year. Out of the mare Highland Glider, he comes from the same family of world champion Godiva Hall.

To date, the fastest 2-year-old is **Rose Run Zeke**, who won by close to 10 lengths in 1:56.3 at The Meadows. He's by Stay Hungry, who impressed last year as a first-crop sire. That group included plenty of fast winners including one that went in 1:49.2, and his highest earners included Three Diamonds winner, Zanatta, as well as Annapolis Hanover. Perhaps Zeke could be a sign of things to come in the sire's second racing crop.

In Ohio, a 2-year-old trotter by Walner named **Pick Pocket** went in a rather remarkably fast 1:58.3 in a qualifier at Northfield Park last week. The proceeding qualifier that morning on the

pace was won by a Captaintreacherous horse in 1:58 and of interest in that race, was third-place finisher Beautiful Lather, who reflects the first 2-year-old to qualify for new Ohio-sire and former world record holder Lather Up.

Saturday morning at The Meadowlands saw the debut of several Greenshoe babies, though they were upended at first asking by offspring from some other prolific sires. A Father Patrick filly named **The Moment**, who was a \$95,000 Harrisburg buy, won the morning's fastest race in 1:59.4. Father Patrick had another winner in the morning as well; a colt named **Alfaromeo** in 2:01.1, whose dam is a full sibling to Southwind Frank. A Greenshoe 2-year-old named Call Of The Wild came close in that morning's second baby race, when he lost by just a head to a Chapter Seven colt named **Situationship** in a race that went in 2:00.4. Another Chapter Seven colt, this one named **Wild Ticket** and a \$200,000 Lexington Selected Sale yearling buy, won the mornings final baby race in the same 2:00.4 clocking. Pricey \$200,000 Walner filly **Dreaming Of Sydney** was another winner in the morning, her win coming in 2:03.2.


In the upcoming 2-year-old qualifiers at Gaitway Farm on Monday, the fourth race will give the first glimpse into sire Captain Crunch. A colt named Blood Bond, by Captain Crunch, was a \$100,000 purchase from the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale and comes from an impeccable pedigree. He's a half to Grand Circuit stakes winners Blood Brother and Bloodline (both Somebeachsomewhere), as well as Blood Money (Sweet Lou). Second dam Arterra produced world champion If I Can Dream, 3-year-old pacing colt of the year and successful sire Western Terror, as well as Cinderalla Guy. He'll be trained by Ron Burke.

The highest priced 2-year-old to race on that card will be Mirage Hanover (Bettor's Delight) in the sixth race. A \$175,000 yearling purchase from Harrisburg, Mirage Hanover is a half to Mad Max Hanover (Always B Miki). Jake Leamon, who trained Mad Max Hanover, a \$50,000 yearling that went on to take a 1:47.4 mark last year at 3 in a Tompkins-Geers split, as well as being second in last year's Meadowlands Pace and Cane Pace, will also train Mirage Hanover.

The lone Greenshoe on the qualifying card comes in the first race, where a filly named Cahira Hanover debuts as an \$80,000 Harrisburg buy. The third foal from an unsuspecting dam thus far, her third dam Image Control was an O'Brien winner back in 1998 and produced fellow O'Brien trotting filly award winner Pure Ivory, who took home the honor in back-to-back years in 2005 and 2006.

Another one of the higher priced yearlings to take to the track Monday will be in the fifth race, when a colt by Captaintreacherous named Concealed makes his first start. A \$160,000 Lexington buy, he's the first foal out of the dam Unseen, and his third dam produced the great Glowing Report, as well as other sub 1:50 winners Perfect Union and Urgent Action.

Casie Coleman cooks up a 'hands on without being there' approach to training

If her parents had made the decision, Casie Coleman might today be Chef Casie, with a whole bunch of Cordon Bleu awards instead of having a whole bunch of O'Brien Awards on her mantelpiece.

She was offered a scholarship at a prestigious cooking school in her native British Columbia. At the last moment she decided that was not where her heart was. She wanted to be a driver of harness horses. Yes, a driver. She thought of training horses as being somewhat boring, whereas driving was where the action was. When asked about her ability as a driver, Coleman's response was: "I think I was pretty good. Maybe a little over aggressive at times, but I think I could make horses go."

Sometime after a near death experience in a fire, the result of which necessitated 22 per cent of her body to require skin grafts, she made the decision to move east which was where the action was. She got some drives, but not many. She needed the means to survive. At that point, she decided to become a trainer. It couldn't be too hard. She had been around horses all of her life. She determined that going the claiming route might be the road at which to begin.

Today you are best known as a developer of young horses, yet for quite some time you had a stable composed of claimers and overnight horses with nary a stakes horse in sight.

"I suppose that you could say that I hit the ground running. At the risk of sounding cocky, I found it rather easy to improve upon horses who were in claiming races. It was quite the norm for me to look at a horse and see that it may have been under nourished, poorly shod or deficient in other areas where good horsemanship, nutrition, hard work and good common sense might turn it around quickly. That's what happened with me. I was doing well, extremely well. Before too long I had a stable of 100 head spread out at WEG, The Meadowlands and Yonkers.

Casie Coleman said she initially wanted to be a driver.

"As is often the case in this business, when you are doing well people are going to say that you are cheating. They said I was using contraband which was giving me an unfair edge over the opposition. Before too long, the folks at WEG began to believe the rumors. At first, they put me in 24-hour detention. Then they upped it to 48 hours. My horses were stabled near Mohawk and they had several in detention at Woodbine where I wasn't. It became an incredible burden. My racehorses were in effect taken away from me. The horses and my schedules were totally disrupted. I had to rely on thoroughbred horseman to feed and look after them. Added to this was the vicious gossip going on accusing me of God knows what.

"All this despite the fact that with a stable of 100 head my record was close to spotless. Claiming races were a strong part of the racing schedule, their numbers had been decreased to the point where it became somewhat difficult to get my horses raced. I decided that a change was in order. I was going to start developing young stakes horses. How could that be more difficult than racing in overnights? After all they all were racehorses doing the same thing; hopefully winning races."

At what point did you think that the transition to stakes horses was going to work?

"I was at the Harrisburg sale in 2008. As I normally do, I had looked at a whole bunch of yearlings. I don't know this as a fact, but I would guess that I look at more, or at least as many pacing yearlings as anybody in the business. I not only look at them initially, but for the ones that appeal to me, I keep going back, and going back and going back again. I don't know how I missed one that I should have looked at, but I did.

"I was walking by the Hunterton Farms consignment and Jim Avritt asked me if I had looked at his Artsplace colt. For some unknown reason I had not. 'Let's look at him,' I said. Wow! I was immediately enthralled. In my mind, I was sure that this was a six-figure colt. There was no way I could afford to buy him. I supposed that I could have rounded up a few owners to come up with the money to buy him if he didn't bring too much. As luck would have it, I was speaking with Steve Calhoun, one of my biggest owners, that evening.

"At the time, Steve felt that buying yearlings was a fool's game. Why buy a yearling when you had to wait so long and invest more money when you could buy a claimer, watch him the next week and get an immediate return on your investment? I happened to mention to Steve that I had looked at this colt with which I fell in love. I told him that he would probably bring between \$150,000 and \$200,000. I couldn't afford him at near those numbers.

"As luck would have it, I ended up buying him at \$50,000. Even at that price I couldn't afford it, but I somehow would make it work. I, together with my long-time partner Ross Warriner, would buy a chunk of him. I'd somehow figure out how to pay for the rest. Steve called me that evening and said 'I see that you bought that colt for less than half than you thought he would bring. Can I get in for part of him?' What? This guy who said that the yearling game was for fools was now wanting to buy into a yearling? I asked him how much he wanted. He said he would take half. I then asked him about yearling buying being a fool's game? 'I'm a person who is always looking for value' he said. 'I thought that buying a yearling for half of what you thought it was worth represented great value'. Of course, that colt was Sportswriter. He earned \$1,566,460 racing and then millions in the breeding shed."

You are now in the yearling game. What came next?

"A huge change in lifestyle for me; all for the better. I gradually worked my way out of the overnight business. I started selling horses and reducing the size of my stable. Doing that made my life less stressful. I thought about going to Florida with my stable and then I just did it. I had just about had enough of the cold Canadian winters. It was especially hard on me because of the residual effects of the skin grafting. I had downsized successfully. The stable was doing well and so was I."

Let's talk about some of your better horses.

American ideal: "This horse had unbelievable speed. Mac Nichol bought him as a yearling for \$72,000. He sent him to Western Canada to race at 2. He was just too good for the horses out there. I got him towards the end of his 2-year-old season. At 3, he drew the 10-hole in the North America Cup, Meadowlands Pace, Breeders Crown yet still earned \$747,570. He would have won more if he had been eligible to more stakes, but there were only a few where we could put him in. He was the only one of my good stud horses where I didn't own a piece. Mac Nichol was kind enough to give me two free lifetime bookings to him. Of course, I got McWicked well into his racing career. His owner Ed James also gave me two lifetime breedings."

Sportswriter: "Probably the one horse to which I owe much of my success. He got me on my way. I learned a very valuable lesson from him. That is, if I were buying yearlings to make sure that I owned a piece of the ones I buy. He is the horse that keeps on giving, both on the racetrack, earning \$1,566,460 and in the stud barn where he has brought in millions. Even at the advanced age of 16, he is still contributing."

Betterthancheddar: "I bought him for only \$30,000 as a yearling. I probably wouldn't have gone much higher. I generally am

attracted to horses with good manners. BTC was anything but that as a yearling. He was a bit of a renegade, even at the sale. He could even sometimes be mean. But he was all manners on the racetrack. If you reprimanded him for his bad behavior he would sulk just like a spoiled child. He ended up earning \$1,634,314 and is now one of the best pacing sires in Ontario."

Vegas Vacation: "He was a bit of a head case and wasn't an easy horse to manage. He was also quite a bargain. We gave \$32,000 for him. He went on to earn \$1,162,272 and gave me my first Little Brown Jug win."

Michaels Power: "He was a homebred. Jeff Snyder gave him to me to train. He was probably the gamest horse that I've ever had in the stable. He was always a little sore, never really lame, but never completely sound either. He earned \$1,908,226 and gave me my second Little Brown Jug."

Betting Line: "Almost certainly the very best horse I've had in my stable. We bought him for what I thought was a bargain at \$60,000. He never trained bad. He never raced poorly. If he had a fault, I have no idea what it might be. He won \$1,908,226, took on all comers and beat them, sometimes seemingly with ease and gave me my third Jug winner."

McWicked: "A truly great warhorse. I had no part in buying or making him. I was privileged to be able to race him as a made horse. He was retired after earning \$4,903,967."

It has been a great ride for you coming from a track in British Columbia to the big stage at WEG, en route to capturing five O'Brien Awards and winning classic races throughout North America. Are there any people who you feel helped you on your way?

"There have been lots of them. I'll just mention five that come immediately to mind. There are others as well.

- 1. "Bill Davis: He was the first great horseman that I was around. I learned so much from him; most importantly how to take care of a horse.
- 2. "David Miller: One of the greatest drivers and finest people in our sports history. Because he can be so quiet, he is sometimes overlooked in discussing greatness. You can trust me on this, he is one of the great ones.
- 3. **Linda Toscano:** A wonderful person and a great horsewoman. She does things the right way. Her results prove that.
- 4. "Jimmy Takter: He's insanely good. Looking at him, I sometimes think that he has to be part horse. I think that may be part of the reason for his overwhelming success. I believe that he has taught himself to think like a horse. He does it all and he does it all well.
- 5. "Phil Coleman: My dad. He has always been there when live needed him."

This year begins a new chapter in your career. You trained your horses at Sunshine Meadows in Florida this past winter. Now you've shipped them to Anthony Beaton in Ontario to race. You aren't giving up training, are you?

"No way. Not by a longshot. I call what we are doing 'Hands on without being there.' I've shipped 14 head to Anthony Beaton, 10 2-year-olds, three 3-year-olds and Linedrive Hanover. I also own a piece of a Betterthancheddar colt that Tony bought in Kentucky. He was kind enough to let me get in as a part owner.

"I'm now in Florida, but plan on going back and forth once they begin racing regularly. Tony worked for me for 11 years. He knows how I like things done and he does them the same way for himself. I expect things to work out well. Its springtime; a time for optimism. I expect things to work out well. If they need some revision, we will do that as well."

Is June too late to be foaling around?

The sires of three of the last five Horses of the Year — McArdle (McWicked, 2018), Art Major (Test Of Faith, 2021) and Shadow Play (Bulldog Hanover, 2022) — were June foals.

Harmonious was a June foal who won the 1990 Hambletonian, at the time the richest edition.

Life Source was a near \$2 million winner a quarter century ago and a June foal.

There have been 46 editions of the Meadowlands Pace and the fastest one belongs to a June foal, He's Watching, 1:46.4 in 2014.

Die Laughing, a June foal, got his nose in front in the very last \$1 million Woodrow Wilson in 1990.

How do some prominent people in our business feel about June foals?

PA eligible, one Ohio eligible and even a colt by The Panderosa. When you mention June foals, the one that stands out so far is a June 5 foal.

So, go figure. As a vet, May/June is the natural time of year to foal. The breeders were the ones who pushed that back some years ago.

Blair Burgess: "They rarely can compete early but there are exceptions like Die Laughing. As Murray Brown would retort: 'The percentage of June foals born is much less than the other months because breeders do all they can to avoid it knowing they will be killed come sale time.'

"I don't necessarily prefer early or late foals and have had good ones born in most months, I think. Early foals are more mature but later foals get outside more because of the better weather. Advantages at both ends of the spectrum. Most stud books close down late June to avoid the June foals. Even that planning can go awry as mares can easily carry 3 to 4 weeks over due date. So much pressure is put on 2-year-olds to show up now, a June foal would be at a distinct disadvantage. Unless in the hands of a conservative trainer/owner."

Pat Lachance: "I like them but you need to have a lot of patience and discipline."

John Kopas: "Back in the mid-1970s, Jade Prince was a late December foal. At that time Delvin [Miller] thought that the breeding season should start in January and that foals born in December would be considered as being foals of the following calendar year. I'm not sure how long that remained in place."

Scott DiDomenico: "A good horse is a good horse. January or June foal, it wouldn't bother me at all."

Steve Katz: "A late foal is better than no foal."

Jack Darling: "It's not ideal, but I would buy an early June foal if I really liked it. I like May foals a lot."

Travis Alexander: "I try to avoid them for the simple reason they aren't as mature as others. Doesn't mean they aren't fast, but from a bone standpoint I stay away."

Bob Boni: "June foals are okay with me, absolutely. Pershing Square was a June foal and I know there are a number of other quality performers who were also like Die Laughing and Bullet Hanover. I would even think that based on fewer foals born in June there is an excellent percentage of accomplishment. Considering there are certainly less foals born in June the percentage of top horses may be higher than any other month."

Paul Kelley: "I'm biased against for the obvious reasons."

Bruce Riegle: "No. They would have to be a special colt and start late and then you are always playing catch-up."

Kim Hankins: "Obviously June foals are a few months younger than earlier foals, and sometimes more immature. But I don't have any statistics to back up my theories."

Carter Pinske: "No problem with them. Sometimes they force you to be easier on them because they're immature and, in the end, they end up better because of it. I've had several nice June foals that didn't get treated any differently."

Brian Brown: "Rather not have them, but I've had two that I can think of. One set a world record here in Delaware, Ohio. Sometimes you can buy a nice horse cheaper because he's a June foal."

Seth Rosenfeld: "Of course, each individual is different, but I think they're often excellent value for yearling buyers willing to show a bit of patience. There's quite a long list of successful ones like: Die Laughing, Shadow Play, Art Major, McArdle, Harmonious, David's Pass. Unless you have an unlimited budget, as a yearling buyer you are going to have to compromise somewhere to get a somewhat affordable prospect. So, if the market offers a discount on June foals, as it often does, that's an advantage for the buyer and a disadvantage for the seller."

Roger Welch: "June foals, they are definitely starting out behind physically and also mentally. They are usually the results of their breeder not wanting to feed a barren mare another season. Then the greed bites them in the rear end at the sales when the buyers shy away from a June foal. If you are not looking for an early season to mid-fall stakes colt at the sales, there's definitely some bargain buys that will suit a buyer — with a no-pressure trainer — just because it says June on the foaling date."

Dr. Ian Moore: "A June foal will not deter me if I really like the individual. I always look at the foaling date, and if it says June, I will look at the yearling's development differently. [Shadow Play] was immature at 2, but towards the end of the season he got really good. I was considering selling him at that point. But he trained in 1:54 off a half in 1:00, and then 1:54 again off a 1:01 half. I decided I might want to take a chance with him. Early on [at 2] I had to put an open bridle on him in February because he was so grabby. He came back thicker and taller at 3.

"As a stallion, we were hoping it would turn out well. He had a lot of characteristics that I look for in a yearling that I hoped he would pass on. He never got the kind of book that SBSW did, but he did quite well. Most of his have a great attitude. As a matter of fact, this is the only year that I do not have a Shadow Play. There were 22-to-23 offered for public sale last year and I just couldn't find one. So, I settled for a couple out of Shadow Play mares.

"I have nine colts this year, four PA eligible, one Ohio eligible and even a colt by The Panderosa. When you mention June foals, the one that stands out so far is a June 5 foal. So, go figure. As a vet, May/June is the natural time of year to foal. The breeders were the ones who pushed that back some years ago."

Late bloomer Naturdays scores first Indiana Sires Stakes win

Memorial Day and the days that followed marked an important transition in the Hoosier State's racing landscape. The holiday signaled the beginning of Indiana Sires Stakes (ISS) competition, and the Indiana Sired Fair Circuit began a four-month slate with programs on June 1 and 2 at the Converse Fairgrounds. One year ago, trainer Matt Rheinheimer chose to point trotting filly Naturdays to the fairs, providing a foundation that is serving her well this season at Harrah's Hoosier Park. The 3-year-old scored a 1:53 triumph in the first leg of ISS action Monday night (May 29), defeating favored Yo Beth D in a \$50,000 division by three parts of a length.

"I just didn't think at that time she was ready," Rheinheimer said of foregoing Hoosier Park for the fairs. "I knew she was going to have to trot a bunch. I didn't want to blow her mind. I just wanted to take my time with her and I thought this would be a better option. She was kind of a late bloomer so we really didn't push her. We just let her tell us where she wanted to go. I raced her at the fairs and she was good, so we kept her at the fairs to make the fair final and teach her something."

Naturdays didn't enter the first round of fair races last June at Converse. She wasn't entered a week later at the same location. The Helpisontheway—Windsongmusclelady freshman didn't make her first start until the series returned to Converse the third time on June 22. She raced fifth that day with Rheinheimer in the bike. It was an accomplishment to line up behind the gate after the challenges in the months leading up to that date.

"I'm not going to lie to you, as a 2-year-old she was very frustrating as I was training her down," Rheinheimer said. "She would make random breaks. I had the trotting hopples off her, I had the trotting hopples on her. Once she got to a certain point, it just seemed like everything clicked."



handled adversity after making a break in traffic.



horse. It was the only time in 2022 that she missed a check, and also prevented her from accumulating the points needed to make the Super Final.

Naturdays finished the season with a victory in the \$25,000 sires stakes consolation, trotting in a lifetime-equaling mark of 1:56. Matt Krueger, who guided her in her last four Hoosier starts, steered her to a more than four-length advantage at the wire. The filly closed out the campaign with eight wins while hitting the board in 12 of 14 starts. Bred by Mervin Lehman, Orla Bontrager, John Lengacher Jr. and Black Creek Farm, she earned \$63,845 for her connections. Just as her recovery from a break at Portland had shown Rheinheimer Naturday's determination, the consolation win offered a glimpse of what could be in 2023.

"That was the deciding factor; that night," he said. "That's why we decided to shut her down and wait for next year. We turned her out until after the first of the year and we were just going to wait until later on in the spring to get her qualified. She was eligible to non-winners of four and five and I just didn't want to throw her in over her head before we had to."

Naturdays turned up at Hoosier Park for the first time this spring on May 10 in a qualifier. That day, Trace Tetrick sat through a :58 half before moving her first up and kicking away from the field in the stretch by nearly nine lengths, stopping the clock in 1:57. She made her pari-mutuel debut May 17, starting from the second tier. Krueger and Naturdays trotted home in :27.1 to finish fourth, timed in 1:54.4.

"Her first start down at Hoosier Park, Matt drove her exactly how he should have," Rheinheimer said. "He left her on the rail and let her trot home. It couldn't have been more picture perfect. We didn't have to qualify in :57 and then drop to :53. It was a gradual thing, and it makes you feel good about it. I was very happy with that."

Monday night, Krueger and the filly used a pocket trip to perfection. As Yo Beth D and Tetrick moved to the lead from post 8, second-choice Naturdays slipped in behind and sat through fractions of :27.3, :56.4 and 1:25.2. In the stretch, the sophomore outkicked the competition to pick up the victory and push her career earnings to \$90,000.

"Going slow, you just think she's a horrible horse," Rheinheimer said. "But, man, when you put the speed to her, she's got a beautiful gait and smooths right out. She's very deceiving when she's going slow, because you just don't think she can trot like she can. We were hoping she would come back to be a sires stakes horse, but you never know. She's come back as well as I could have hoped she would. I've been very happy with her so far."

Maria Rice – A trainer living the dream

Maria Rice is closing in on a very important milestone in her career as a harness horse trainer. After being in the sport for almost 18 years, Rice is approaching 1,000 wins as a trainer.

Although this may not seem like such a feat after seeing larger stable trainers' stats, for a smaller stable, this is quite an achievement.

Born in Syracuse, NY, and growing up in Chittenango, NY, Rice's mother always made sure her daughter owned a horse which kept young Rice busy showing her four-legged friend.

When mother and daughter relocated to Vernon, NY, they began going to the harness track and the young girl was hooked.

"While I was in college my mother met and married a harness horseman who introduced me to harness racing," Rice said. "I began taking paddocks for trainers William Bailey, Jack Bailey and Rocco Manzi. When I met my future husband, trainer Jack Rice, we started working together and today we operate a stable of 15 horses we train in Kentucky."

At that time, Jack was a top catch driver who raced mainly on the Monticello/ Vernon circuit.

Jack and Maria met 23 years ago when Maria's sister was working for Jack at Vernon Downs. In 2013, Jack and Maria loaded their horses in their six-horse trailer and relocated to Buffalo Raceway and never looked back.

"Today, we mainly base out of the New York State, but the past two years we have been shipping to race at Oak Grove in Kentucky," Maria said. "We call these three months 'a workcation.' Although we still work full time, it seems like a little break for us, thus, we combine work while enjoying horse heaven."

Kentucky is now the place to race your standardbred for the program they offer is phenomenal. The state highly supports our industry and subsidizes the purses. The Kentucky Sires Stakes are open to the foals of any mare that resides in the state for six months.

Although the Rices have not yet had a world champion, they have trained a lot of track record holders and open class horses who raced at smaller venues.

Jack's accomplishments include more than 1,500 wins, \$5 million in purses, three dash titles at Vernon Downs and a win in Russia while representing the U.S. at the Annual International Driving Tournament at the Moscow Hippodrome.

The Rices recently have added yet another track record holder to their resume, the 4-year-old trotting filly, Yanaba.

On May 9, the Trixton mare won her second Kentucky Sires Stakes in 1:52, making it two in a row at Oak Grove. That win lowered the previous track record for aged trotting mares of 1:53 by Beltassima that was set in July of 2022.

After driver John MacDonald cleared Yanaba to the front over the odds-on favorite Eternal Lee, the Trixton—Zanna Royal daughter took home the honors for owners Ann-Mari Daley, Jared Daley, and Oleg Ivutin. That was Yanaba's sixth win in 25 tries, and pushed her winnings over \$200,000.

When Ann-Mari Daley had to entrust her stakes mare, Yanaba, to someone other than her husband Dan, she immediately reached out to the Rices, assured that her 'baby' would be in good hands.

Jack and Maria make a great team and have never had a fight in nearly 24 years. That's a remarkable feat for any husband and wife who works, lives, and plays together for that long.

"Jack and I consider every thought and detail and it's 50/50 on all decisions," Maria said. "We don't consider this a job, but a passion, and are blessed to be able to do this on a daily basis, together, and earn a living."

Some of the team's stars are: China Dream, Noble Legend, Protect Blue Chip, Little Joke and Queenie Rocks, among others.

Amongst all those stable stars, Maria doesn't have one favorite, but two.

"I would say it's a tie between Queenie Rocks and China Dream," she said. "Both have a special place in my heart, but there are many others that I'd need an entire page to list."


Maria's fastest win as a trainer was with Surfer Beach (1:48.4) taken last year at Oak Grove..

Top French trotter Etonnant may race at The Meadowlands this summer

Richard Westerink's 2022 Elitloppet winner Etonnant (Timoko) may provide an exotic element to The Meadowlands this summer. Westerink is aiming Etonnant at the John Cashman Memorial on Hambletonian Day in August.

"If Etonnant starts in the Cashman Memorial, he will not race in the International Trot at Yonkers in September," said Westerink to French media *Paris-Turf*.

In other European news, Thierry Duvaldestin-trained **Oracle Tile** (Ready Cash) was served a perfect second-over trip in Friday's (June 2) \$80,000 Prix Pythia at Vincennes in Paris. When driver Théo Duvaldestin gave his horse the signal for attack with a half mile remaining in the race, Oracle Tile flew to the front and held chasing opponents behind him in a mile rate of 1:57.2 over 1.7 miles.

American-bred **Periculum** (fifth in the 2022 Hambletonian) made his third start in Europe for owner Stall Zet in Saturday's (June 3) \$60,000 Ina Scots Ära for 4-year-olds. Periculum made a break 100 meters before the car left the field and the Muscle Hill son found himself fourth over when he regained his stride. He was three-wide in the last turn, but attacked from the far outside resulting in a safe win in a strong mile rate of 1:55.2 over 1.3 miles.

USTA withdraws Spyder 3D from approved sulky list

The U.S. Trotting Association announced Thursday (June 1) that as the result of recently reported issues with the sulky model Spyder 3D and after a detailed investigation held by the USTA,

in cooperation with the sulky manufacturer, the decision has been made to withdraw it from the USTA approved sulky list, effective immediately.

"There were issues reported to us recently regarding the Spyder 3D sulky and we moved immediately to investigate, which led to the decision to withdraw it from our approved list of sulkies," said USTA chairman of the board Joe Faraldo, who also chairs the USTA sulky committee. "As USTA directors and members of the sulky committee it is of the utmost importance to ensure absolute safety for all participants, both human and equine."

As a result of the uncertainty, on Tuesday (May 30) the USTA, under the direction of Faraldo, took immediate action to remove the sulky from the USTA approved sulky list, pending an investigation. The following special notice was sent to all racetracks, racing commissions and horsemen's associations:

"The United States Trotting Association has withdrawn the sulky model "3D", which is manufactured by Spyder, from the USTA approved sulky list, effective immediately.

"A detailed investigation, in cooperation with the sulky manufacturer, is being conducted currently, to ensure absolute safety for all participants, both human and equine. At the conclusion of the investigation, an announcement will be forthcoming to the industry stakeholders.

"In accordance with USTA Rule 18.21 — Sulky Performance Standards/Approval, the USTA sulky committee, led by Faraldo with other members of the committee, USTA directors Jordan Stratton, Jeff Gregory, Steve McCoy, and Sam Beegle, met on May 31 (Wednesday) and made the decision to withdraw approval for the Spyder 3D sulky."

'Way' proves special in NJSS at Big M

Special Way continued her dominant ways at The Meadowlands Friday night (June 2), upping her win streak to 10 while completing a three-race sweep of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for 3-year-old fillies on the trot by taking the \$240,000 final of the series in a lifetime-best 1:51.4.

Trainer-driver Ake Svanstedt was in no particular hurry with the daughter of Walner—Special Hill, sitting fifth past the quarter and half—making the backers of the 1-9 favorite a tad nervous—as Mambacita reached those markers in :27.3 and :56.2. Special Way vacated the rail after the half and started her march toward the leader as Mambacita hit three-quarters in 1:24.1.

Racing wide while third into the stretch, Special Way put up a final quarter of :26.4 to win going away by an easy two lengths. Secret Volo rallied to grab second with Walner Payton third.

"I have to share with you what Ake said to me [right after the race]," said co-owner Marvin Katz with a laugh. "He said 'She's so good, she overcame my bad drive. She's exceptional."

After starting her career with losses in her first two starts, she's been a perfect 10 since.

"Actually, her first start, Sarah [Svanstedt] drove her and they were still working on her," Katz said. "She wasn't quite ready yet and she was careful with her and so forth and it was just a good drive and a good first start. She was 70-1 and she closed her last quarter in :26.2. We just knew that this was a talented horse. We didn't know perhaps she was this good, but we knew she had some talent."

Can Special Way join Ramona Hill (2020) and Atlanta (2018) as fillies to win The Hambletonian? Katz was non-committal.

"I'm thinking I'm going to enjoy this evening tonight," Katz said. "I'm going to celebrate this and we'll go one step at a time. How's that for a political answer?"

Special Way is owned by George Siegel's Brittany Farms LLC, Katz and Al Libfeld. She's now 10-for-12 lifetime, good for earnings of \$847,475. She returned \$2.20 to win.

'AIR' POWERS BY: In the \$240,000 NJSS final for 3-year-old colt and gelding trotters, Marcus Melander trainees finished 1-2 as **Air Power** blew past 9-5 favorite Oh Well nearing the wire to remain perfect in three seasonal starts.

Since the top two were both driven by Tim Tetrick in their most recent outings, Tetrick piloted the public choice [and 2022 Mohawk Million winner], so Andy McCarthy picked up the drive, his first behind Air Power.

"It really worked out for me," McCarthy said. "I'm not sure [how I got the drive] to be honest with you. I know Marcus had a bunch in there and, you know, I know [Marcus' brother] Mattias had been driving the horse before Tetrick raced it last week. But, yeah, I just got lucky, I guess."

Luck was also on his side from a trip perspective.

Oh Well left hard from post 7 but couldn't find a spot at the rail around the first turn and had to go on with it, reaching the lead at the half in a taxing :55.4. Air Power was in Nowheresville at the time, racing eighth at the rail, but as horses vacated the pylons, McCarthy advanced his horse to sixth at the three-quarter call and then fourth at the top of the stretch.

Oh Well was still doing good things on the lead at the head of the lane, as McCarthy and Air Power tried desperately to find a path to the winner's circle. Inside the eighth pole, Air Power swerved to the outside and lunged past the favorite to win by a half-length nearing the wire. Up Your Deo was third. The mile time of 1:50.4 was a lifetime-best.

"I watched his replays and it looked like he just really loves to pass horses," McCarthy said. "I figured there'd be a fair bit of speed in there and I was hoping for a bit of a flow and trip on the outside, but that didn't look too good. So, we had to take a shot the other way. It worked out. The seas parted and I got out when I needed to. He definitely had a lot of trot finishing up. I actually had to slow him down there a little bit."

A winner of half of his six lifetime outings, Air Power, a colt by Muscle Hill—Beyond Blue, returned \$9.60 to win as the 7-2 third choice in the betting. He's now earned \$165,367 for owners AMG Stable Inc, Rick Wahlstedt, Kenneth Kjellgren and Heights Stable.

A LITTLE MORE: McCarthy topped the driver colony with three winners on the card. All-source wagering totaled \$2,866,645 on the 13-race program. Gabe Prewitt was the winner on night 1 of the "Battle of the Masterminds" handicapping contest. Prewitt tallied \$665.60 after having an \$8 ticket on the Early 50-cent Pick-4, which returned \$41.60.

DP Realordeal's 1:48.4 effort shatters Plainridge track record

The racing strip at Plainridge Park was on fire Thursday afternoon (June 1) as the top three events all yielded sub-1:50 miles. The fastest time was turned in by **DP Realordeal** who became only the third horse to ever pace under 1:49 in the 24-year history of Plainridge Park.

It was the \$20,000 conditioned pace where Odds On Blockchain (Luke Hanners) left and set a torrid pace while DP Realordeal (Bruce Ranger) sat drafting right behind him. The leader cut fast fractions of :25.4, :53.4 and 1:20.4 as DP Realordeal followed and the rest of the field was trying to keep pace. At the top of the lane, Ranger pulled to advance, feeding DP Realordeal line. Odds On Blockchain fought gallantly in deep stretch but got caught before the line, where DP Reaordeal won by a quarter length in 1:48.4.

The time was a lifetime mark for the winner and it also broke the 18-year-old track record for 4-year-old pacing geldings. The old standard was 1:49.2 set by Maltese Artist in 2005 who was also driven by Bruce Ranger.

It was the fourth win in seven Plainridge outings this year for DP Realordeal (\$5.20) who is owned by William Hartt and trained by Lance Hudson.

The other two sub-1:49 miles paced at The Ridge were registered by the great Shartin N and her stablemate Lyons Sentinel, who both paced in 1:48.1 in the Clara Barton Distaff Pace in 2020 and 2021, respectively.

Live racing will resume at Plainridge Park on Monday (June 5) at 4 p.m. and there will be a \$3,076 carryover in the Jackpot Wicked Hi-5 pentafecta in race 6.

Breakfast with the Babies begins

Breakfast with the Babies, generously sponsored again this year by Jules Siegel's Fashion Farms, kicked off the 2023 season at 9 a.m. on a cloudy Saturday morning (June 3) with temperatures in the mid-60's and a slight opposing breeze in the homestretch at The Meadowlands.

The first winner of the year was **Alfaromeo**, a Father Patrick colt who went all the way for trainer/driver Lucas Wallin. He set moderate fractions through three quarters then sped home in :28 seconds to hold safe over pocket sitter Security Protected (Tim Tetrick) in 2:01.1. Alfaromeo was an \$85,000 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale (LEX) purchase by Mal & Janet Burroughs, Alfaromeo Stable and Howard Perlmutter's Pit Bull Stables. He was bred in KY by Black Creek Farm, Northern Lane Farm, Four Corners and Hickory Hollow Stables.

Situationship, a Chapter Seven colt trained and driven by Ake Svanstedt, rolled by his rivals through the stretch in a purposeful 2:00.4 winning effort while trotting home in :27.3. French Kronos (Mattias Melander) cut the mile and stayed on for third with Call Of The Wild (Brian Sears) splitting that pair. The winner was an \$85,000 (LEX) buy for Tristan Sjöberg's Knutsson Trotting, Jeff Gural's Little E, LLC and Tomas Anderson. Crawford Farms is the breeder.

The Melander barn sent out the third race winner, an easy task as all three in the race came from that stable. **Dreaming Of Sydney** (Tetrick) led early, released Landaluci (a Greenshoe sister to Hannelore Hanover) as they approached the half then tipped and edged past that one in the :28.3 end to the 2:03.2 mile. The winner is a Walner filly, bred by Kentuckiana Farms, LLC and Eddie Gran, sold for \$200,000 (LEX) to AMG Stables, K. Kjellgren Heights Stable and Mantorp, LLC.

The Wallin stable struck again with **The Moment** (Tetrick), a Father Patrick filly who closed nicely from third down the stretch, ending the 1:59.4 mile with a :27.4 individual last quarter for the win. Good Faith Hanover (Dexter Dunn), also from the Wallin barn, cut fair fractions and held on for second. The winner was an \$85,000 Harrisburg (SHS) purchase for Al Libfeld, Marvin & Lynn Katz and Sam Goldband. Shmuel Farhi is the breeder.

Marcus Melander added a second win with **Wild Ticket** (Sears) who moved to the front going to the 1:02.1 half then sped home in :28 seconds to hold off Stormcloudfashion (Tetrick) from the pocket and Supernova Hanover (Dunn) who was composed early and very willing late, home in :27.2. AMG Stables, K. Kjellgren Heights Stable and Mantorp, LLC. share ownership of the winner, bred by Al Libfeld and sold for \$200,000 in Lexington last fall.

The day's only 2YO pace went to Robert Hirsch's Huntsville colt **I'm A Believer** (Jordan Stratton) who sat behind Price Of Memories' (Josert Fonseca) slow pace then rallied through the inside to best that rival in 2:03.2, home in :28.3. A \$40,000 (LEX) yearling purchase, the winner is trained by Mark Ford and was bred by Southwind Farms.

Among the horses racing in qualifiers on the card, **Christchurch**, currently third in Dave Little's Road to the Pace, was still a handful for Dexter but did rate some early then dashed home in :26.3 on the end of a 1:51.3 mile on what was not a great day for speed.

Allywag Hanover was considerably more focused today than last week's debacle and put up an effortless 1:52.4,:26.3 mile for Pelling and Todd McCarthy.

Justice made his first appearance of his 4-year-old season for Svanstedt and trotted home impressively in :28 seconds to win in 1:55.2; **Strong Poison**, a top freshman pacing filly for Burke & Gingras scored in 1:53.4.

CMPA changes elimination guidelines for isoflupredone

The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency would like to remind trainers, owners, veterinarians and other stakeholders that the elimination guidelines (EG) for isoflupredone changed as of April 3, 2023. The change is detailed in the table below. Testing protocols for isoflupredone have been adjusted accordingly.

Only the EGs currently published on the CPMA's website should be related on when making treatment decisions for a racehorse.

The CPMA strongly recommends that you consult your veterinarian on any decision to administer supplements or medications to a racehorse.

Isoflupredone

Previous elimination guideline:

Intramuscular (IM), 48h / 24 mg IM / single

Current elimination guideline (effective April 3, 2023):

Intra-articular (IA), 6 days / 10 mg IA / single

Rationale for change:

The IM use is no longer recommended due to the variable and extended elimination of isoflupredone by this route.

Thoughts on harness racing being a "club sport"

Thoughts on **Dean Towers' column** on Greg Schuler's club sport tweet. In my opinion Schuler's tweet was kind and gracious and Dean Towers reply isn't as penetrating as it should be. I grew up in an era where thousands would navigate Chicago winters for Hawthorne winter racing. When the judges didn't "intervene" the broken down horseplayers (BDH), as we were known then, did. The language thrown at the drivers along the apron is memorable, as were the nights the BDH literally tried to burn the place down. The "club" is much deeper and sinister than Towers would lead us to imagine and to fret about.

Years ago, I was told, then, the most "unclub" racing was in Ohio because those farmers literally drove hours to race, trained and drove their own horses, and were hellbent to not go home empty handed. Catch drivers changed that. Honestly, the best drivers are like watching Lebron, Jordan and yes, Durant. Electrifying. But today's best drivers are very different from the early days Joe Marsh Jr., Campbell, O'Donnell and Luc and Sears. There were occasional "club" races but nothing like the "club" race cards we see today.

I have seen \$3,000 purse races in the past competed like it was the World Trotting Derby. Remarkably, a few drivers from near that era compete at The Big M. Their efforts in much more meaty purse races are toiled to yield a result that is seemingly known by the club before the horses are even called to the gate. In the past, one would rationalize 'they got me in that race,' but bet to form and I have a shot at recovering. Not so much anymore today because the "club" rules.

Like the other night, a 40-something shot beat an odds on favorite in a trot race. Almost none of the betting public were in that club. The Meadowlands is the race place for harness and there and elsewhere will always catch my attention, especially stakes races. But not too many of my dollars and many nights just as an observer.

The allure to thoroughbred racing, as Schuler's tweet suggests, is the club is not so ingrained. It's there for sure. But take Churchill. Maidens go for \$100k plus. Jocks get 10 per cent. Betting pools dwarf harness. A \$200 win ticket doesn't come close to tipping the odds. When gambling is the game, evil things can

happen. Judges have sat down thoroughbred jocks for failure to "persevere" or in plain talk you didn't give a full effort. Only once in harness racing do I recall such a consequence and it's widely played on YouTube. The driver was suspended because he all but choked a horse down just before the wire to clearly avoid winning. With club members from the racing office to the judge's booth, and with international drivers now on the scene, we don't get enough intervention, say in things like reviewing betting patterns where that longshot trotter made the odds on favorite unravel like a cheap claimer or, get this, a mandatory meeting at the club where Federal prosecutors discuss integrity and the weight of the law when club rules conflict with the public interest. With all due respect for the drug integrity thing, at the very least track owners and race officials (Judges) should protect the public. Not the club.

Fans in the stands

Thanks for the article about where are all the fans at the race track today. I was introduced to both harness and thoroughbred racing as a child. In the summer, almost every Saturday, and later Sunday when the tracks started running that day, we would go to Delaware Park and Brandywine Raceway to enjoy a day or night of live racing. In the 1960s, it would not be unusual to have a crowd of 10,000 or more at Delaware Park and a slightly less crowd at Brandywine. So what happened? Several things: more new sports to attract old horse fans, the lottery, casinos and now sports betting.

Add in the addition of great high technology products to bring the show to our homes and there is less of a reason to go to the track to see and bet on the horses. I am now a senior citizen and have to admit I attend the races live a lot less now. The convenience of betting and seeing the races at home is just too good. I still go occasionally to see the live racing usually when the track is having its best races or if the weather is really nice. The other thing not mentioned in the article is the cost to go to the live races. While most tracks do not charge admission anymore, there still is the cost to drive there which sometimes means even paying tolls on the road to get there. For example, for many years, I attended the races at The Meadowlands but being from Philadelphia it is about a three hour drive and between the gas and NJ Turnpike tolls it got expensive to go. So now I still watch and bet on the races but usually from home. But I do miss the old flavor of live racing and the large crowds that used to attend. There is nothing like seeing and hearing the horses pass by at speed or being there to see a new record broken or a great close finish of a race.
