Rene Allard latest to plead guilty to doping charges

The trainer faces up to five years in prison and has agreed to pay a \$628,553 penalty.

Harness trainer Rene Allard, among the more than two dozen individuals indicted in March, 2020 as part of a conspiracy to dope race horses, changed his plea to guilty on one felony count of drug adulteration and misbranding on Thursday (June 2). He had been scheduled to go to trial on June 27.

Allard will be sentenced on Sept. 13 and faces up to five years in prison. In addition to the prison sentence, Allard also agreed to pay a \$628,553 penalty.

The indictment in which Allard was charged included five others with ties to

the harness racing industry. Louis Grasso, Donato Poliseno, Thomas Guido III and Richard Banca have also entered guilty pleas. Conor Flynn, a former assistant to Banca, has been cooperating with the government and testified against Lisa Giannelli. Giannelli, who worked with convicted drug distributer Seth Fishman, took her case to trial and was found guilty on charges of drug misbranding and alteration.

Banca and Grasso will be sentenced on Sept. 6. Poliseno will be sentenced on Sept. 7 and Guido is set to be sentenced on Sept. 29.

With Allard having entered a guilty plea, it appears that all of the doping cases involving those who were involved in standardbred racing, have been settled. Gregory Skelton, Ross Cohen, Nick Surick and Chris Marino were among those originally indicted but their names were not included when the government issued a superseding indictment.

The high-profile thoroughbred trainer Jason Servis is among the few who continue to fight the charges against them. Servis' trial is set for January.

The evidence against Allard included stomach-churning wiretaps in which jokes were made about the deaths of several horses trained by Allard. The FBI intercepted a phone conversation between Cohen and Grasso discussing the deaths of horses who were given illegal drugs by Allard. It reads (exactly):

Cohen: What's going on with the Allard death camp?

Grasso: (Laughter) well I didn't get anymore emergency calls

yesterday so I am assuming...

Cohen: Assuming the number stopped at 7?

Grasso: Well yeah

Cohen: How many died?

Grasso: Three

Cohen. Jeez. What were you thinking?

Grasso: Three or two maybe.

The pair continue to discuss the situation before wrapping up:

Grasso: ...One of them just died on the table they just cut him

open and poof it died.



Cohen: Holy f-k did they do an autopsy?

Grasso: Their heart rate was like triple they were breathing real heavy their membranes were going f-ing purple.

The original indictment involving Allard also included testimony from FBI agent Bruce Turpin. Turpin stated that Allard stabled at a training center run by Banca in Middletown, NY and that his barn was raided on or about March 9, 2020. There, they found multiple empty syringes, the drug Glycopyrrolate, epinephrine and vials labeled "Thymosine Beta" and "for research purposes only."

The March, 2020 indictment was far from the first time Allard had found himself in trouble. In 2017, a horse Allard trained tested positive for Codeine and Morphine — both Class 1 drugs — following a race at Woodbine. In 2016, the Allard-trained horse Julerica tested positive for the Class 1 drug Oxycodone at Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs.

In a related development, the convicted doper Chris Oakes has begun serving his three-year sentence for drug alteration and misbranding. Oakes has been sent to the federal prison USP Lewisburg, a medium-security facility in Kelly Township, PA.

Lewisburg has been the home to many high-profile inmates. The list includes John Gotti, Whitey Bulger and Jimmy Hoffa.







Fortune smiled on John Fodera

How Fodera went from principal and then president of St. Peter's of Staten Island to one of the harness racing's top owners.


One would be inclined to guess that there isn't any Catholic High School president who is a part owner of over 40 standardbred racehorses. One then might be surprised that John Fodera fits that profile. This scribe caught up with Fodera and his lovely wife Barbara while they were attempting to negotiate a traffic jam on the Garden State Parkway.

John has owned horses since 1961 when he bought part of a \$2,500 claimer, Sir Carlith, at Freehold Raceway, being trained by his cousin and horseman Jim McGovern. He never had another trainer prior to or during that time until McGovern passed away at the too young age of 49 in 1982. Since then, Fodera's experience in harness racing has been never ending and quite successful.

"I started with claimers beginning at Freehold and then branched out to Liberty Bell and the New York tracks Roosevelt Raceway and Yonkers. Pretty much all my horses pre-Meadowlands were claimers and they continued to be such for the first few years at the Meadowlands.

"The reason for the gradual change to babies and Grant Circuit types can probably be summed up in two words – Myron Bell.

"After the Meadowlands opened, I purchased an owner's box in the grandstand. As fortune would have it, the Brittany Farms box was immediately next to mine. Myron, Brittany's racing manager, was there most evenings as was I. We became friends. If you know Myron, you know that you can't spend too much time around him without the subject of breeding coming up. It wasn't too long before I became intrigued with pedigrees myself. Although at the time my major interest was still claimers, more specifically horses that could be secured through the claiming route and be improved upon. With some exceptions

that goal was achieved. Not to be bragging, but I tried to get my knowledge of claimers (or those that I would hope to become claimers) to be comparable to Myron's knowledge of pedigrees. Without a doubt, my greatest success in the claiming arena was a horse named Natural Talent. I missed out on claiming him as a 3-year-old. At the beginning of his 4-year-old season at the Meadowlands, he was in for a claiming tag of \$25,000. With allowances for age and taxes, we ended paying \$31,250 for him. The thrills and excitement that he furnished us cannot come close to being measured in dollars and cents. He eventually became a \$100,000 claimer and won over a dozen races for us."


Q: In the early years at the Meadowlands, you were doing quite well in the claiming and overnight games. In the midst of your success, you decided to switch to yearlings. Why?

"I didn't really switch per se. It was more of an evolution to yearlings and stakes horses. I was learning, thanks mostly to Myron and also Martha and Milton Frank, dear friends who occupied the owner's box on the other side of mine. The Franks and Myron were heavily involved in the procurement and then the training and racing of young stakes horses. They were having lots of fun and excitement and really enjoyed that part of the game. Over a period of time, I joined some of their ownership groups. We did quite well. I was really enjoying it while being very successful with claimers and overnight horses. I began

studying yearling catalogs and became fairly knowledgeable of the pedigrees that I liked and those that I didn't. I suppose the turning point of my love of the yearling game was the first time I went to Lexington for the Grand Circuit and the yearling sales. It is now 25 years later and I haven't missed a year in Lexington since. I love the search for the great horse similar to reaching for the Golden Ring. I am an eternally optimistic person and owner as well. I also greatly love the camaraderie and excitement associated with the entire Lexington experience. Since then, I've taken my yearly vacation from school without fail in order to be there."

Q: You have another life apart from the horses. You are the president of St. Peter's of Staten Island, the oldest boys Catholic high school in New York City.

"I'm proud that I've been affiliated with St. Peter's all of my adult life. I started teaching history and Latin 54 years ago after graduating from Georgetown University. I became the school principal in 1990. In 2017, I was contemplating retirement, but I was asked by the pastor to remain as the school's president and chief fundraiser. Of course, I accepted. St. Peter's is a great institution. It was founded in 1917. It is the oldest boys Catholic high school in New York City. It is still the only Staten Island high school to ever win the city's basketball championship."



Q: You have 41 horses in training. How are they divided and who is training them?


"There are 25 2-year-olds, 15 3-year-olds and one 4-yearold. The majority of the horses are with Tony Alagna, who I consider to be a closer friend rather than just a trainer. He is an exceptionally talented trainer but perhaps more importantly a great person. I am so proud that I attached myself to his program before he rose to the great success he has achieved. I first knew him when we had horses with Erv Miller. He was Erv's second trainer before he decided to go out on his own. This young man was so impressive that our ownership group decided to send him most of our horses. It was a great show of faith to a man who was just embarking on a career in running his own stable. Tony lived up to and well beyond all that we hoped he would become. I look back to that time. We initially were focused on overnight horses including claimers who we would campaign at the Meadowlands. We quickly included yearlings in the game plan. I recall a conversation with Tony at that time where we were plotting our game plan for his stable. I recall him saying that he would anticipate never training a stable of more than 25 head. So saith the man who now has over 150 in training. In addition to being a gifted and hard-working trainer I consider Tony and his mother Donna Lee to be two very good friends. I also have horses with Jennifer Bongiorno, Brian Brown, Noel Daley, Dan Lagace, Chris Ryder, Ake Svanstedt, Nancy Taker, Linda Toscano and Lucas Wallin."

Q: Which is the best horse that you've had?

"In terms of talent and achievements that would have to be Ramona Hill. In terms of the horse closest to my heart that would be Boulder Creek, thanks to Mark and Tammy Silva. It's not often that you can own one from his earliest career and then have that horse win almost \$3.5 million dollars. He is still alive and is retired and living a good life on a farm in North Carolina with Chris Coyle."

Q: What has been your greatest thrill in all your years in the sport?

"Without a doubt that would be Ramona Hill winning the Hambletonian. It was both a thrill and a memory to last a lifetime. My partners Steve Wienick and Robert Leblanc and I were near crazy cheering her on though the length of the Meadowlands stretch. Steve took a video of our performance and Tony Alagna actually put it on You Tube. I forget how many views it got, but it was an unbelievable amount. I also had another reason to get in on Ramona's ownership. I owned her dam Lock Down Lindy for a good part of her racing career before she became a broodmare. It was kind of sad that Ramona's Hambletonian coincided with the time when COVID-19 had become a big part of America. The Crawfords were at the Meadowlands, but so many of our friends, our partner Brad Grant, and relatives were unable to come and share in our joy."

Q: Let's speak of COVID and how it has affected you and your lifestyle.


"Thankfully neither I, my wife Barbara, nor any of my children have had it. My grandchildren have had some minor strains. Thankfully, nobody was ever very ill. The effect on the boys at St. Peter's was much more significant. Not only did a good many of them get sick with the virus, but it probably significantly impacted on their scholastic progress and social growth. The boys were forced to stay home learning remotely. We did the best we could do considering the seriousness of the situation, but it was a huge difference with the kids not being in school and having their learning schedule put into disarray. The bottom line for many of them has been that they have in effect lost two years of their valuable youth."

Q: How active have you been in terms of the ownership of your horses?

"I would say quite a bit. I like to think that the three most important components of my life are first, my family, second St. Peter's Boys High School and the third would be the horses which I own. I'm not active in the sense that I ride or am involved in the training of the horses. But I watch every race and replay in which I have a participant. I follow their progress as they are being trained. I like to think that I can tell when a horse in which I own a piece is not at its best. I hope I'm not a frustrating owner who needs to be constantly asking questions about the horses from my trainers but I like to speak with them quite often and keep track of their status. I firmly believe where you a place horse to race and setting the proper schedule and management of your stock is a key to success."

Q: You've won a serious number of very important races through the years.

I've been very fortunate in that respect. Ramona Hill's Hambletonian was the most important one. But we won several other stakes events with her as well. I've also won three Little Brown Jugs with Tell All, Mr. Feelgood and Captain Barbossa, who was picked by Trevor Richie, who is a good friend and has



been a horse partner in our groups. Captain Barbossa was a maiden prior to winning the race and that was also the thrill of a lifetime. I'm fairly certain he was the only maiden to ever win the race. We won three Metros with Yankee Skyscaper, Artspeak and Exploit, the Goodtimes with Pilot Discretion and Quite Easy, the Pepsi North America Cup with Tell All, the Kentucky Futurity with My MVP as well as several Breeders Crowns with the likes of Boulder Creek and American History and numerous other important and maybe some other not so important events. I share many good memories with Jimmy Takter and my ownership with Martha Frank when we raced the great filly and mare Shake It Cerry."

Q: How are things shaping up for this coming racing season?

"I would say very well. I guess, though, that I probably have said that every year. If you are not an optimist, then you probably don't belong in this business. I have 25 2-year-olds in training, that is the most I've ever had. I hear varying degrees of optimism about them. Tony has the greatest number. He has been around 1:58 with many of the pacers. Isn't that amazing? There was a time not all that long ago when if you had a 2-year-old that could go faster than 1:58 you'd have a horse that could make quite a bit of money for you. Today that won't get you much more than getting hot. I've been very privileged to have been associated with so many quality partners, the majority of whom I already mentioned and they are great friends. Without doubt, I share most of my business relations today with Robert Leblanc and Joseph Sbrocco, both of whom have a great insight into horse racing and include my inner circle of friends. My best friend and partner for over 30 years has been Steven Wienick, together we have formed In the Gym partners. I'm looking forward to the 2-yearold season especially with Treacherous Penny and Captain Van Gogh (Alagna), Downbythebanks (Nancy Takter), D'Apper (Wallin) and Beach Cowgirl (Bongiorno) to name a few. However, before that, there are three colts hopefully giving me both excitement and promise for another try at the North America Cup, namely, I Didit My Way, Night Hawk, and Pebble Beach.

"Also, Tony is bringing back Fast as the Wind, last year's winner of the Kindergarten and Valley Victory preparing him hopefully for the Hambletonian. Obviously, I consider myself one of the luckiest and most blessed horse owners in this business. I would be remiss if I didn't conclude by stating that my role model and most respected gentlemen in harness racing is George Segal, owner of Brittany Farms, who epitomizes everything that our great racing industry should represent."

Striking it rich with Rich Strike

I just had occasion to glance over the extended pedigree of the recent Kentucky Derby winner, Rich Strike, and the inbreeding was, to plagiarize from the colt's name, striking.

As you'll recall, Rich Strike was the second longest shot ever to win thoroughbred racing's most prestigious race. That he was the beneficiary of a deadly speed duel between the two favorites doesn't change the fact that on May 7, 2022 he was the best horse in the 20-horse field.

He only drew into the race at the very last minute, thanks to the latest possible scratch by trainer D. Wayne Lukas.

Here, a personal opinion RE: the 20-horse field that Rich Strike laid to rest. I've always felt that a 20-horse field was basically an unfair contest, what with the bumping, jamming, collisions, and being forced to race wide around the turns.

Rich Strike, however, starting from as far as out as the gate went, still managed to find his way through and around all the clutterers without giving up too much ground on the turns. That was to the credit of his jockey, Sonny Leon, who learned his trade on the second tier tracks of Ohio, and learned it well.

But back to Rich Strike and his pedigree. He's inbred, 2 by 3, to Smart Strike, and his sire, Keen Ice, is inbred, 3 by 3, to Deputy Minister. That's about as deep of concentration of blood as you're going to find in any standardbred, and I've found it so rarely as to come to doubt it actually exists in any of our present day stakes winners.

But it surely exists in Rich Strike, and I offer it as proof positive that, when done properly, inbreeding can create a synergy, i.e. two plus two equals seven. It's also notable that Smart Strike is sired by Mr. Prospector, who proves again that it's the 2-year-old racing year that gives the best insight into a stallion's future potential as a sire.

Mr. Prospector raced only at 2, when he was devastating, despite being trained by someone who was roundly criticized by everyone who had a printable opinion. He wound up standing in Florida, where he got very limited opportunity. Despite numerous handicaps, Mr. Prospector showed someone with keen eyesight that he was a real sire. I'm not sure who it was, but a major Kentucky breeder braved the Florida alligators and snakes, bought Mr. Prospector, and the rest is all Rock 'n Roll, as they say in Detroit.

Wait, before we hit the dance floor, two quick final thoughts about Rich Strike. I don't like his chances in the Belmont. I can't give you any specific reasons, but it's just my intuition.

However, I do like his chances as a sire, even though he only made four starts at 2. Clearly he was no hell as a racehorse at 2, but he did win \$38,069, which isn't totally chicken feed.

But it's his inbreeding that gives him a real shot as a sire. Now we'll see which Big or Medium Sized Dog from the sport of king's is smart enough to scoop him up. Or maybe even a Small Dog, who knows, when you're talking about the rich folks who live on the other side of the tracks. And hands down, this week Rich Strike wins the I'm My Own Grandpa Award, an award created and awarded by this kid only.



Back to our real world, I was flattered to hear from Andy Cohen, asking me some questions RE: his two nice mares, High Minded and Find Happiness.

For those who aren't familiar with him, Andy is a nationally celebrated legal analyst, and also an extremely smart and equally nice guy. He's been a long-time client of Linda Toscano, one of the best trainers in our business.

Both of Cohen's fillies are by Captaintreacherous, and out of Auniqueaquistion, by Cole Muffler. The only place I could think to look was their 2-year-old racing year when I tried to figure out which was the best bet to be a good producer.

No clues there, because they both raced successfully at 2. Since I don't believe that a mare's phenotype, the living horse, which includes her racing record, has anything to do with her genotype, which is her genetic profile and includes her inheritable speed gene, I had nothing to go by.

So I started working my way back through the dams of these two mares of Cohen's. Nothing rang a bell in my memory till I hit their fifth dam, Ocean Bird. She belonged to one of my closest friends, who was also a transformative figure in the history of our sport, Stan Bergstein. Stan left harness racing a lot better than he found it, and no one has taken his place since we lost him. Stan always made me proud to be a Jew.

Going back another generation I found a good producer named Ella Pence. One of her daughters was a mare of mine, Tarella, by Tar Heel. She clicked several times with one of my sons of Adios, Airliner.

Airliner was another great example of the importance of 2-year-old racing brilliance to foreshadow future sire potency. Airliner won the first 2-year-old stake of his year, at Goshen, beating all the other good colts in his year.

He came out of that race with some physical problems that couldn't be solved in those early days. I should mention that he was owned at two by Leonard J. and Helen Buck, which meant he was selected as a yearling because he was great bred and a terrific individual. The Bucks bought only the best and price was no object.

Ned Bower, a good trainer and driver, was hired as a private trainer by the Bucks when Airliner was 3. Bower, a good friend, told me that even though Airliner was completely broken down by then, he could still feel glimpses of his ability and class when he sat behind him.

The Bucks finally gave up on Airliner, and sent him through the Harrisburg sale that fall. Two brothers who operated a breeding farm called Shadydale, in Georgia, bought him for \$3,700 in the auction ring.

Despite every conceivable handicap, Airliner did enough from his first three crops to convince a young, but ambitious breeder from Hanover, PA to syndicate Airliner for \$600,000. The horse went on to be one of the top pacing sires of his day. And this kid was the young guy who syndicated him.

I still haven't answered the basic question Andy Cohen asked me about what to do with his two full sisters, High Minded and Find Happiness.

So here it is: Sell them both this fall, Andy. While there's no reason they can't both be top producers, I see you strictly as a racehorse guy, one who loves the action. They'll sell well, and you can take the money and buy one or two chancy yearlings that you and Linda both like. And if your luck holds true, you'll have a lot of fun with them next year and the year after.

And every time they go to the gate, they'll have the added advantage of me cheering them on, loudly.







Paul MacDonell, Randy Waples honored to be joining the Legends Day lineup

The two drivers, due to be inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in August, will join the lineup of eight other Hall of Famers on June 12 at Clinton Raceway.

Driver Paul MacDonell may be making his first appearance at Legends Day on June 12, but he has been at Clinton Raceway in spirit for all previous 10 editions. A giant photo of him driving Lifetime Dream to victory in the 1993 Breeders Crown Mare Trot for local trainer Butch Elliott is prominently displayed on the back of the Clinton grandstand.

"I have that connection with Clinton and I always love going there. First of all, Butch Elliott is a good friend who trained her and I like to see him every so often, so it's cool to reconnect there," MacDonell said.

As I get a little bit older and as I watch my father get older... he'll be 76 this year, I don't know how many more times I have to drive against him. He's my guy... In the early days, I think I spent more time watching what he was doing in a race than watching what I was doing in a race.

Lifetime Dream's Breeders Crown victory at Mohawk Raceway near Toronto capped off a wild celebration in Clinton.

"It was a big day... a big thing back then for that community," MacDonell said.

So big that MacDonell is guessing he might hear more about Lifetime Dream from Clinton racing fans than another superstar horse he drove: Somebeachsomewhere.


Joining MacDonell as a first-time Legends Day legend this year is driver Randy Waples. Both Waples and MacDonell will be officially inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in August.

At Clinton, they will join fellow Hall of Famers Doug Brown, Steve Condren, Wally Hennessey, Trevor Ritchie and Waples' father, Ron, in contesting the \$15,000 Legends Day Trot. Hall of Famers John Campbell, Bill O'Donnell and Dave Wall will also be at Legends Day to sign autographs.

Those appearing at this year's Legends Day have collectively earned nearly \$1.2 billion in their racing careers (by Standardbred Canada accounting).

"It's quite an honor to even be associated with those guys, that's for sure. I'm looking forward to it," MacDonell said.

Randy was even more effusive about becoming a Legends Day legend: "I'm wickedly pumped for it," he said.

Though, he stressed he was humbled to even be considered to joining the other superstars on the track and at the autograph table.

"Say you've got O'Donnell on one side and my father on the other side and then someone is coming down the line to get autographs, I think it's going to flash into my head, 'Man, they really don't want to ask me for this autograph, but they don't have a whole lot of choice," Randy said, laughing.

"I have a tough time putting myself with those guys... These are my heroes. Every one of them, they were all my heroes, Randy said. "These guys are just in a completely different echelon than I put myself in... Though, when I was driving, I was never intimidated by them. I don't think I was intimidated by anybody, but I revered them.

It's quite an honor to even be associated with those guys, that's for sure. I'm looking forward to it. ??

"It's not just Brownie and the Condren, it's O'Donnell and the Ronnie Waples and John Campbell... it's Trevor Ritchie, Paul MacDonell.

"Watching Trevor behind the gate, he could get his body to go with the trotter. I've never seen anybody do that... He had a way that when a horse would trot that his body would move the same way... There were times behind the gate with him when I thought he was going to lose a trotter... he'd be trotting, but not trotting solid and his body would adjust with the way that that horse was trotting and the next thing you know that horse would set and then he'd go."

Both Randy and MacDonell said being part of Legends Day likely will solidify the fact they are due to be inducted into the Hall of Fame later this summer.

"Once I get amongst them and get there and get involved in it, it'll probably hit home a little harder then," MacDonell said. "Just to be able to hang around those types of guys and be a part of it... I'm just really looking forward to it."

Randy said he's looking forward to driving against his father in the Legends Day Trot.

"As I get a little bit older and as I watch my father get older... he'll be 76 this year, I don't know how many more times I have to drive against him," Randy said. "He's my guy... In the early days, I think I spent more time watching what he was doing in a race than watching what I was doing in a race."

Having two generations of the Waples family appearing at Legends Day will be a treat. Sadly, the opportunity to honour the immense contribution three generations of the clan has made to harness racing was lost when Keith Waples died in 2021 at the age of 97. Keith was Ron Waples' cousin.

Still, this year's Legends Day is sure to be a celebration, particularly after being postponed last year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The event, as it has in recent editions, will raise money for the Clinton Public Hospital Foundation.

There will be an online auction from June 5-9 at www.clintonraceway.com. On Legends Day itself, there will be a silent auction, autographs with the Legends from 2-3 p.m., the Legends Day Trot will hit the track at 4 p.m. and a chicken barbeque will follow the races. All the food has been donated and all sales will, again, go to the Foundation.

Previous editions of Legends Day have raised more than \$260,000 for the foundation. In 2019, Legends Day raised \$50,000 before the pandemic put a one-year pause on the, normally, biennial event.





Complexion of sport's best sophomores up in the air

With a number of top 2-year-olds from 2021 already out or yet to return to form, the landscape has already changed for the allimportant 3-year-old division.

Top horses from last year are just now returning to the track in qualifiers and in early season races, and already the landscape of many divisions has changed from how it last concluded.

Beginning with the glamour division, the premature retirement from last year's 2-year-old pacing colt divisional champion Monte Miki is highly unfortunate. The Metro and Breeders Crown winner excited towards the end of last year but it was announced a month ago that he had suffered a tendon tear. In his absence, perhaps early-season favorite status defaults back to Pebble Beach. Last year's 1:48.4 winner was in a division Saturday of the Somebeachsomewhere at Woodbine Mohawk (results available elsewhere in this issue), as was another one of the more notable Breeders Crown entrants, Beach Glass. Gulf Shores is another that was raced in an action-packed Saturday in his seasonal debut at Scioto. The Brian Brown trainee just missed by a nose to Monte Miki in the Breeders Crown. The fastest sophomore thus far belongs to Night Hawk. The Meadowlands Pace-eligible colt by betting line took his 1:48.4 mark last week at Pocono by a neck over Mad Max Hanover in a PA sire stake division. Hammering Hank is another top colt from last year that comes to mind; he debuts on Wednesday in a Pennsylvania Sires Stakes division at Harrah's Philadelphia.

From the fillies' side of last year's 2-year-old pacers, it's too early to say for sure but Niki Hill's seasonal debut from last week may prove to be fateful. At the very least, it's another division that has the potential to look dramatically different this year. Never traveling smooth throughout her PASS test at Philly, she broke stride in the latter part of the mile and was then reported as injuring her front right ankle. Trainer Chris Ryder said in that

interview that she'll be back, but it seems unlikely that she'll be the same imposing filly that took her to runner-up Horse of the Year consideration last year. It would seem like her absence opens the door for Treacherous Dragon to assume the driver's seat as the stakes season gets into gear. She battled last year with Niki Hill and is off to a fast 3-for-3 start in 2022, the most recent win coming last week in an easy PASS win for Tetrick and Pelling. Sea Silk is another that warrants attention as another top freshman filly and who looked vicious in her seasonal debut a few weeks ago; remains in Ohio for her second start Saturday.

Sticking with the 3-year-old fillies but on the trot side, it's all going to depend on how those horses can progress from 2 to 3. The talk for most of last year was all about Venerable. The young filly that beat colts to win the Mohawk Million looked untouchable for much of the season, but Joviality made a super strong late push in that division in winning the Breeders Crown (from post 10) and then following that up with a win in the Goldsmith Maid. This year, Joviality has continued on that forward path, most recently winning in 1:51.2 at Vernon while Venerable has broken a couple of occasions at least to this point, has regressed somewhat time-wise from last year. It's still very early, but this is another strong division that includes New Jersey Sires Stakes champ Fashion Schooner, Jiggy Jog S, Misswalner Fashion and I'm sure many others that I'm overlooking.

The 3-year-old colts are another division that's totally wide open. King Of The North won this group last year on the strength



of his early season performance, but he wasn't as threatening by year end. He was on track to qualify back Saturday for the first time. Horses from this group that have already established fast marks this year include: Pretender, Temporal Hanover and Looks Like Moni. Last year's Breeders Crown champion Rebuff is set to qualify back, and Crown runner-up Branded By Lindy has already come back with a quick 1:52.1 qualifier right out of the gate. Even horses like Jonas K who comes off that record mile at Plainridge could be heard from in this wide-open division.

Where it looks like there is some level of stability is at the top of the open trotting ranks. Ecurie D Dk didn't win a Dan Patch last year, but it wasn't for lack of ability. He overpowered rivals in his only two starts in North America last year, the Allerage and the Breeders Crown. In his lone start thus far in 2022 from the Cutler two weeks ago, he won in 1:49.1. It doesn't seem out of the question that he could beat the all-time trot mark of 1:48.4. Of course, it is a long year and it remains to be seen who might be able to step up and challenge him. Normally, there would have been a high level of anticipation to see how last year's Trotter of the Year, Jujubee, would handle the transition into racing against older horses. But he's another that's been bit by the injury bug and is hopeful to target a later season return.

The older pacing female division is full of intrigue. If Lyon's Sentinel can remain as good again this year as she's been for the past couple, how does she rate against the likes of Test Of Faith? How about other newly-turned 4-year-olds such as Fire Start Hanover and Oakwoodanabella – can they step up against the open mares?

It's a similar story in the free-for-all pacing division. Last year's champ Allywag Hanover is still qualifying back and it'll be interesting to see if any fresh threats can challenge him. Linedrive Hanover who was unknown when last year ended has proven to be a total killer. Bettor's Donttell comes off a 1:47.3 mile at the Meadowlands. Last year's 3-year-old champion Perfect Sting has been retired but his chief rival Charlie May is still going and how will he stack up? There's at least a half-dozen other horses in this category that have shown staying power throughout the year in this division. In the aged trotting females, Manchego is another that's now retired but Atlanta may get a fresh threat in Bella Bellini.

For all the uncertainty that's come with the changing dynamics since last year has ended, it surely sets the stage for what promises to be an exciting 2022 stakes season.







Dover In Motion going farther from Indiana more often in his sophomore season

The first leg of Indiana Sires Stakes competition for sophomore trotters and pacers was contested during a special Memorial Day card Monday, May 30 at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. Over the course of 10 divisions, favorites claimed victory in all but one race. **Dover In Motion**, last year's freshman trotting colt champion, produced the most dominating performance, winning his \$50,000 division by more than five lengths for driver Ricky

Macomber Jr., trotting a 1:52.4 mile in his sophomore debut.

"I told Ricky after he warmed up, 'He's really good. I expect a new lifetime mark tonight," trainer Jamie Macomber said of her charge. "I expected him to be very full of himself and confident in himself. When it came up in (1):52 with the earplugs in and Ricky shutting him down, that was impressive. You just can't wait to go tell the horse thank you and good job."

Since Dover In Motion first stepped on the racetrack in 2021, the son of Dover Dan-Keystone Sadie has proven nearly flawless. At 2, the gelding produced an unblemished record over the Hoosier Park oval. He prevailed in each of his eight Indiana starts, including victories

in each of six Indiana Sires Stakes legs before capturing the \$270,000 Super Final. That night he established a new speed record for 2-year-old gelding trotters at the track with a 1:53.2 mark

His only defeat last year came when owners M&M Racing and Norbert Maza took a chance and entered Dover In Motion in the Mohawk Million, where he raced sixth while battling sickness.


"I think everything played out that he was 2 and it was his first time shipping. He was sick. We got stuck at the border for a while. I don't know that there was that much to learn other than it was a bad experience for him. Just a baby trotter shipping for the first time," Macomber recalls of the trip north of the border.

Dover In Motion finished the season with \$309,400 on his card and divisional honors in Indiana. In turn, the partnership rewarded Macomber for the special season. She was given a 10-per cent interest in the trotter, no questions asked.

"Isn't that awesome? There was no conversation. They just said we are giving you 10 per cent," Macomber said. "Shocked. Speechless. You have a horse that just made \$300,000 and they say you now own 10 per cent. Thank you is not enough."

The trotter was turned out at the farm of Ora Miller, one of Dover In Motion's partners, in northern Indiana after the season. When he returned to Macomber's barn at Hoosier Park to begin preparations for the 2022 campaign, the conditioner was pleased with what she saw in the champion.

"He came in and his chest was so much bigger and his butt was so much bigger. I was so happy to see how well he wintered in the field," she said. "As soon as he hit the track, it was never

enough work to make him happy. Every day. You start slow miles and build up. He was just shaking his head, saying 'Come on, let's keep going!'"

If there was a challenge for Macomber this spring, it was that her pupil came along so quickly and with such ease, she had to work to keep him happy as she mapped out a schedule to his first start on Memorial Day.

"When he started training, he always wanted to go faster or go more. It was so awesome to see that he came back with the same attitude that he left with last year. His work ethic is amazing," the trainer said. "I had him ready way early. I had to qualify him because he was so mad at me for continuing to shut him down training. Then I turned him out for two weeks after I qualified the first time because my only option at Hoosier Park was the open."

Last year the connections took a conservative approach with the gelding, opting to race him outside Indiana only once. When it came time to stake Dover In Motion this year, the idea was the same: focus on Indiana Sires Stakes and Hoosier Park open stakes and take a few select shots on the Grand Circuit. The sophomore's dance card includes the Yonkers Trot, where he was supplemented for \$6,000, Stanley Dancer Memorial, W. N. Reynolds Memorial and Earl Beal Jr. Memorial.

"Ora and I both agreed to write down what we wanted and then we went over it and we made adjustments. I didn't have the Yonkers Trot on my sheet, but he really wanted to try it," offered Macomber. "We both agreed on a light staking schedule this year in hopes of keeping him forever and having a good racehorse when we're done with his stakes season."

After his impressive Memorial Day performance, Dover In Motion will compete in the second leg of Indiana Sires Stakes action Wednesday, June 15. Then he ships to the East Coast where eliminations, if necessary, will be held for the Yonkers Trot June 24, with the final slated for July 1. The Reynolds, also held July 1 at the Meadowlands, is Plan B should the gelding not make the final. The Stanley Dancer Memorial is two weeks later.

Around the barn, Dover In Motion is entertaining, making each day an event. The conditioner admits he is very similar to Beckhams Z Tam, whom she previously trained and sent out to victory in the \$527,500 Breeders Crown final for sophomore pacing colts in 2017.

"As personalities go, they're the same. They know when to rest, they play all day. They both have their head out over the gate all morning. Come pet me, come play with me. Let me bite your shoulder. Let me lick your jog cart.' As soon as the barn work is done, the lights are off, and their lunch is complete, they just go to sleep," she said. "The horse makes me happy every time he steps on the track. I'm so lucky to have one of the best Indiana breds in the state."

Dr. Nena Winand's first memory of horses is when her father took her to Penn State where they had a program on breeding Percherons.

"My family was not involved in the sport of harness racing, and I didn't grow up in the business, so seeing first hand this huge, awesome animal was a big treat for me," she said.

"My family would often visit the various livestock breeding programs that Penn State offered because it was 'free entertainment' for my parents and their four children.

"Right from the start I was totally captivated by horses. Unfortunately, we couldn't afford to own one, so my exposure to them was limited. I am sure my passion for rescuing horses today started as a result of my wishing and hoping for a horse every single Christmas. Unfortunately, my dream wouldn't become a reality until I was 42 years old.

"One thing I give my parents credit for is instilling in me and my siblings the idea that animals or pets were an important life-long responsibility, which has truly shaped my career and life," said Winand.

It would be years before Winand would get involved in harness racing.

"Social media is a great tool to locate someone you have lost contact with. Although some people say Facebook can be a little too prying into your personal affairs, it isn't as bad as they think, for it was there that I reconnected with my former veterinary classmate and friend, Barbara Krauss Roland in 2018. Barbara filled me in on the years we were apart and informed me she was now married to trainer/driver, Royal Roland, who raced horses mainly in Iowa.

"Although I had ridden with a veterinarian that did work at Hanover Shoe Farms and had seen the breeding aspect, as well as treating standardbreds during veterinary school, up until then I had never personally attended a harness race.

"Barbara informed me I could watch the Iowa fair circuit races live on Facebook. When I did, I was in awe, for what better way to get acquainted with this thrilling sport than watching a fair race? After all, who doesn't love fair racing?

"My friend encouraged me to become a member of the Iowa Harness Horsemen's Association and I am still a member today.



"I followed the Iowa horses avidly and still do when time permits, and Barbara's husband, Royal, has pretty much been a voice of reason and temperance in my racing involvement," Winand said.

Winand was born in Bellefonte, PA and raised in State College, PA. She attended the Iowa State University College of Veterinary School, earning a bachelor's degree in Animal Science and then went on to get a Master's in Veterinary Science with an emphasis on immunology from Penn State University. Winand took a job in research at the Iowa State University College of Veterinary Medicine and graduated from veterinary school in 1986.

After graduating, she moved to Ithaca, NY, where she completed a pathology residency and PhD in Medical Genetics at Cornell Veterinary medicine and was hired as a faculty member.

Today, Dr. Nena and her husband live in Groton, NY.

"In 2005, my husband and I purchased a 15-acre farm where we live with our horses. We bought the farm for at that time I owned two horses and it was ideal having them live at home, rather than boarding them somewhere.

"Presently I own 11 horses — all retired except for one youngster — and provide all their personal care and needs. I've ridden and shown hunt seat and reining horses, and have a retired show horse from each of those disciplines here. However, I'd been bitten by harness racing and was determined to one day own a racehorse.

"In addition to my five retired horses, I adopted Winners Only (Credit Winner—Only Dreaming) from the Morrisville College Foundation when she was retired from breeding. In 2019, I rescued Archangel Hanover (Credit Winner—Angel Pie) and brought him here to live out his life, and in December 2020 I did the same for Lady Mattgalane (Artscape—Mary Mattgalane) as well as the foal that was growing inside her.

"It was 2019 when my life-long dream of owning and racing a racehorse would come true. I partnered with Winners Circle Racing LLC, Joseph M. Dougherty, and trainer, Kimberly Gilman-Daios, on a yearling filly. We subsequently added three more yearling fillies: one trotter and two pacers to the Gilman Stable at Vernon, NY.

"The 2- and 3-year-old fillies will race at the County Fair and Excelsior events this season and we will continue to race the 4-year-old in overnights. I additionally partnered with Winners Circle Racing, John A. Campagnuolo and trainers Rob and Patti Harmon on a trotting gelding named Itsonlymoneyhoney (Iowa circuit) in 2020. I had followed the horse's career as a 2- and 3-year-old in Iowa and it was great to be able to partner on him. He has been racing successfully out East and is currently at Tioga Downs."

Let's talk about Lady Mattgalane.

"Matty is the real Superstar Female of harness racing — not me. It was December 23, 2020 when I received a message from Liz Ingersoll who runs Vindonah Horse Shelter in Beaver Dams,

NY. about a standardbred mare a dealer had intercepted before going to a low-end auction.

"The rescue did not have the funds to buy her, but as luck would have it, our gelding Itsonlymoneyhoney had just won two races at Chester — on December $11^{\rm th}$ and again on my birthday, December $18^{\rm th}$ — and was in to race on Christmas Eve, and won again! I call it all a miracle and the best birthday present I ever had for I gave the money we won to the rescue to buy the mare."

Lady Mattgalane is by Artiscape out of Mary Mattgalane. She earned \$378,257 at 2 and 3 and took a mark of 1:51 at 3. Her stake wins as a 2-year-old included the Eternal Camnation, Countess Adios, She's A Great Lady elimination, and a NJSS leg.

"As a 3-year-old Mattie won the NJSS final, the Ladyship, The Tarport Hap and the Miss New Jersey elimination. It was heartbreaking that she was a really good racehorse and ended up pulling a buggy. Lucky for Mattie (and me) a dealer noticed her pulling the buggy despite her lameness. He followed her home and purchased Mattie from her owner for she was too lame for roadwork anymore. Her owner told the dealer he had bred her to one of his Percheron stallions, but believed she was barren.

"When Mattie arrived at Vindonah for quarantine, a vet examined her revealing she was emaciated, and the ex-rays showed not only an old untreated P1 fracture with advanced arthritis, but a new full P1 fracture. Further testing confirmed she was indeed in foal and the vet said Mattie needed 5 plus months total stall rest, which didn't sit well with her for she hated being alone in a stall.

"That's when I adopted Mattie and moved her to my farm for grass turnout. We started her on a re-feeding diet, wormed and vaccinated her. When her udder started to develop she was moved to Cornell Equine Research Park on June 8th to foal. We weren't sure her exact due date, but watched her closely. She spent the summer at Cornell and finally foaled a big, dark bay colt on August 1 during an all-day deluge.

"We named the colt Weather Tracker aka/Cantore after meteorologist Jim Cantore. Cantore is now 9 ½ months old and has started training for trail riding and fox hunting. I am committed to giving them both the best care possible.

"This year Mattie was bred to New York stallion So Surreal for I believe she deserves a shot at throwing a fast, gutsy racehorse like she was.

"Mattie now spends her days in my large pasture with her girlfriends Winners Only and Ruffs Summer Wages (retired broodmares) and Archangel Hanover. She gets around fine and is very happy, active and fit."





Two tragic tales from the betting windows

Once upon a time, I was a proud member of a group of racetrack slackers who populated the harness track grandstands. We set up shop on a trio of tables on the lower concourse near the glass doors that opened to the apron where the trotters and pacers turned for the home stretch.

A freewheeling group prone to taunting, laughing, and boasting, this was our social life. These were different times. We gambled against the other folks attending the races at the racetrack and sported cigarettes, paper tickets, paper programs, and a dash of misogyny. A few of the guys, New York Mork and Perfecta Phil, were very good handicappers and prone to smirk at lesser horseracing handicapping minds.

Two of those lesser minds were Wally the Weasel and me, two of the worst and loudest handicappers of the bunch. Everyone in our motley crew understood who was excellent at handicapping and who was not because we bellowed our prerace pronouncements with enormous confidence. We also made our post-race laments with great grievance and blame.

How bad was I at handicapping? One of my claims to the poor horseracing wagering hall of shame was the day I lost money on a race and, less than five minutes later, lost money on the latest racing innovation, the simulcast replay.

After the race under discussion, I asked anyone and everyone, "How could the six come home last? It's impossible."

New York Mork, already turning his race program to the next race, muttered, "The number six wasn't last."

This comment irritated me, "He was last. I watched his every step."

The situation escalated and resulted in Mork taunting me with, "Ten bucks say the number six wasn't last."

I waved a ten spot in the air, "You're on."

We stomped through the glass doors to a large television screen to settle the matter with a small posse in our wake.

I told you Mork was sharp. Unseen by me was the nine, the trailer in the field. The driver of the nine horse mistimed the starting gate by about an eighth of a mile. Sure enough, long after my horse finished, the nine pranced across the screen. I swear the nag was smirking, as was Mork, when I forked over the ten bucks.

Worse, or better, depending on your perspective, was "The Case of the Gagging Weasel."

I remember it. All of us present remember it like it was yesterday. Prerace, Weasel bellowed, "I got a cold trifecta, eight, seven, six. Watch it and weep, suckers."

The sequence of numbers in his wager was unusual, as was Weasel in his porkpie hat and black high-top Keds. Most of us glanced at the tote board and saw that all of Weasel's horses were bombs. We rolled our eyes. Along with Weasel, we moseyed up to the wire fence near the finish line to watch the race, our standard practice.

As the horses approached the starting car, Weasel reiterated his wager by shouting, "Eight, seven, six, just like the countdown to a rocket launch. Book it, baby!"

Like a dream come true, the horses turned toward the finish line, eight, seven, six, well ahead of the pack, well-spaced, none of the three horses gaining or losing an inch. Weasel was screaming, "Oh, Oh, Oh, Oh," like a woman giving birth to a large child. Suddenly, deep in the home stretch, like a rocket ship out of the clouds, the number one horse exploded on the tiring trio and passed all three in the last few feet. The tote board displayed 1-8-7-6.

Weasel let out a primal, guttural scream, a sound that still echoes in our ears decades later. All eyes latched on to the face of the wounded Weasel, staring at the tortured man with a single ticked pinched between his thumb and index finger.

We were watching when, and this is not a joke, Weasel took his single trifecta ticket and slipped it into his mouth like a potato chip.

Weasel was glassy-eyed, chewing and swallowing, when the announcer intoned, "Hold all tickets." The number one on the tote board flashed red, a prelude to the disqualification of the

number one horse for violation of the breaking rule in the first turn. The red words "official" flashed when the remnants of his ticket were near his thorax, perhaps trachea. The 8-7-6 payoff was \$4,410.

I whispered to Mork, asking if the Heimlich maneuver was possible. Mork shook his head and began to describe various teeth and the processes of mastication and digestion.

Mork and Downtown Danny each took an elbow of the mumbling, catatonic Weasel and escorted him back to his chair in the concourse. We took turns sitting next to him for the rest of the program, sort of a suicide watch. NOBODY had the heart to tease or joke. This remarkable tale will endure throughout wagering history.

The plunging attendance of patrons who physically attend the racetrack grandstands has slowed to a trickle. Modern gamblers wager from home on devices. Ease and comfort have arrived at the expense of friendship and socializing.

And Weasel? He recovered, but we still did not mention the swallowed ticket. A year after the incident, he moved to a condo in North Carolina, a state that does not even allow internet wagering. The racing gang moved away from the grandstands into the real world. Me? I still play the trotters and pacers on my laptop, no teasing, nobody tracking my lousy wagers, no testosterone flowing, no ticket swallowing. Sad.

Five Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots divisions took place on the 14-race \$176,300 opening night card on Friday (June 3) at Grand River Raceway. Each division was won by a different driver/trainer combination, highlighted by a win for a special trainer/owner partnership in the closing division.

In the final \$22,200 Grassroots division, **Kipper Whipr Snipr**, piloted by Louis-Phillipe Roy, set the fastest mark of the five winners, trotting a mile in 1:57.1 for trainer Rob Fellows.

"I was expecting that, he trains on a half," said Fellows. "It was a perfect trip. He got around the first turn, he settled in, and he made his move. Other horses came at him, and it was a pretty good mile."

The son of Royalty For Life won a Gold division at Flamboro as a 2-year-old, and was third in the 2021 Super Final. The gelding is a special horse for Fellows because he's owned by Edward Wilson.

"He's the first person I ever caught horses for, back in the early '70s at the Port Perry Fairgrounds," said Fellows. "That's where I started this journey. I've known him for 50 years of my life and he's still a big part of it."

Hp Maestro (Il Sogno Dream) was second for owner, and breeder Claude Hamel. Brett MacDonald drove the Benoit Baillargeon trainee. Dave Boughton drove Royalty for Life son Come Home For Life to a third place finish for local owner-trainer Don Lindsey of Fergus, Ont.

In the first Grassroots division second choice **Tuxedo Attire** at 4-5, left from post three and Doug McNair moved the son of Archangel to the front heading into the first turn. The gelding led at each quarter mile marker for a two-length win in 1:57.2 for trainer Stephen Bossence.

"He had better post position than some of the better ones in there, and I thought if he could stay ahead of them leaving the first turn it would be good," said Mcnair. "He trots the turns perfect, so that's what makes him excel on this track."

Owned by Bossence, and partners Stephen Palermo, Richard Thompson, and Derek Reid the gelding now has three wins from six starts in 2022.

Louis-Philippe Roy and Archery Seelster made a move through the far turn, but the Wheeling N Dealin colt couldn't catch

his rival after leaving from post seven. The Marcel Barrieau trainee moved over \$49,000 in career earnings for Barrieau and co-owner Gestion Mastel Inc. Lenis (Il Sogno Dream) rounded out the top three for owner Christopher Leonard.

Marvin Hagler, a son of Crazed, got a pocket trip for Jody Jamieson and powered to a two-length win in the second Grassroots division.

"I was able to get good position off the gate, which is always important on a half-mile track, and I was able to turn that into a win," said Jamieson. "The strategy was to get away close and keep him trotting. When I moved him, he responded to win pretty handily."

The Mark MacQuarrie trainee moved over \$42,000 in earnings with the win for MacQuarrie and fellow owner Mary Padden.

Gary Lance trainee Fireinsidemyveins (Muscle Mass), driven by Chris Christoforou, led until the stretch run, before finishing second for owners Gary Lance, Brian Samis, and Sandy Moulton. Johnny William son, and 2021 Grassroots Champion Armstead Cole was third for owners James Armitage, Grant Watson, Sheryl A McDiarmid, and Dr. Roland Armitage.

After two odds-on winners to open the evening **Ricky Resolve** went off from post three at 14-1 to win the third Grassroots division.

A back-and-forth first half-mile featured multiple leaders before Anthony Haughton moved the Resolve gelding into first at the three-quarter marker, and he held on for a half-length score. Trained by Mark Johnson it was the first OSS win for the Denise Ball homebred.

Radio Lab earned second position, finishing gamely after sitting seventh at the half-way point for trainer-driver, and husband-wife duo Ashley and Ed Hensley. The son of Crazed now has two second place finishes in three starts this year for the Hensley's. Mass Attack (Muscle Mass) finished third for owners Peter Clements and Barry Klages.

Star Power Hanover reverted the trend back to favorites in the fourth Grassroots division, with Samuel Fillion driving him to an impressive five length score over Promise For Life.

A Wheeling N Dealin son who was entered into the Mohawk Million last season, the Luc Blais trainee adds a Grassroots win to a Gold division score as a 2-year-old, in his sixth career OSS start. He has over \$120,000 in career earnings for owners Determination.

Promise For Life (Royalty For Life), owned by R A W Equine Inc/S&R Racing Stable, and driven by Bruce Richardson gave a challenge around the far turn, but the Rene Dion trainee couldn't match the star power. Resolve gelding, Resolute Bay was fifth for TheStable.ca

Do It Like Bobbi and Sea Silk win Ohio Sires Stakes second legs

Five of the top spots in the two divisions of the Ohio Sires Stakes second leg for 3-year-old pacing fillies at Eldorado Scioto Downs Saturday June 4 were all sired by Downbytheseaside with **Do It Like Bobbi** and **Sea Silk** picking up victories. Each division went for a purse of \$55,000.

In the first division, **Prancing Queen** with Brett Miller grabbed the lead at the quarter pole in :26.1 and set the pace through the first half in :55.1.

Tony Hall pulled Do It Like Bobbi just past the half and set their sights on the leader heading down the back stretch. Do It Like Bobbi grabbed the lead around the final turn and held off the hard charging favorite, Cape Cod Hanover with Chris Page, to win by three-quarters of a length. Prancing Queen finished third.

Do It Like Bobbi tripped the wire in a new lifetime mark of 1:50.2, just a fifth of a second off the track record.

Trained by David Elliott and owned by Stephen Sexton, Do It Like Bobbi won for the third time in four starts this year. She had now won 10 of 15 lifetime and pushed her earnings to \$73,154.

In the second division, 1-9 favorite Sea Silk with Page in the bike sat patiently through the first three quarters and then went three-wide in the final turn firing down the lane to win going away in 1:51.3.

At the start, Secret Side Piece with Cam McCown and Dragons Revenge and Dan Noble raced to the first quarter pole in :27. Dragons Revenge took the lead and hit the half in :55.2 with Secret Side Piece second, Bittrsweetsymphony and Tyler Smith were third with Sea Silk sitting fourth.

Down the back stretch, Sea Silk followed the cover of Bittrsweetsymphony as they closed the gap on the leader, Dragons Revenge, who hit the three-quarter pole in 1:23.3.

Rounding the final turn, Page swung Sea Silk to the outside charged down the stretch and pulled away to win for the second time this year.

Secret Side Piece finished second with Bittrsweetsymphony, the daughter of Well Said, finishing third and spoiling the Downbytheseaside sweep.

Sea Silk is trained by Ron Burke and owned by Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi, Knox Services, and Hatfield Stable. Sea Silk has won 11 of 13 her lifetime starts and has earned \$639,092.

Ohio Sires Stakes action resumes Saturday June 11 at MGM Northfield Park when the 3-year-old colt pacers take the track for the second leg.

Pebble Beach, Magical Arthur take Beach splits; Four-year-olds battle in Graduate

The Grand Circuit came storming into Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday night (June 4) with Graduate Series and Somebeachsomewhere divisions contested.

Kicking off a busy stretch of Grand Circuit racing in June, a pair of Somebeachsomewhere divisions offered a mini preview of next Saturday's Pepsi North America Cup eliminations.

Top Cup contender **Pebble Beach** went coast to coast on the front to win the first \$81,000 "Beach" division in 1:51. Driver Todd McCarthy sent the Noel Daley trainee to the lead immediately and got full control, posting fractions of :27.1, :56.1 and 1:24.1 before a :26.4 kicker to secure the victory.

"I was pretty fortunate to get cheap (fractions)," said McCarthy. "Ideally I do like to race him off a helmet, having him out front there tonight I was a little concerned how he would be, but he finished up really strong and I was super happy with him."

Kolby Two Step rallied to finish second, beat 2 ¾ lengths behind the winner. Sport Secret and Chucky Hanover completed the top-four.

A son of Downbytheseaside, Pebble Beach picked up the first win of his three-year-old season. The Daley trainee raced from off the pace in his season debut on May 21 at The Meadowlands, pacing a final three-quarters of 1:20 to finish second.

Pebble Beach stamped himself as a pre-season Cup favourite following an 11-start rookie campaign that included seven wins, \$361,250 earned and a mark of 1:48.4. He is owned by Patricia Stable, Joe Sbrocco, Country Club Acres and Laexpressfoderadeovolente.

A \$2 win ticket on Pebble Beach returned \$2.40.

Magical Arthur came out on top in a wild \$80,000 Somebeachsomewhere division for driver Trevor Henry and trainer Anthony Beaton.

Competing in a field of five, Magical Arthur and Henry blasted out to the lead, posting a :27.1 opening-quarter. Favourite Stonebridge Helios and driver Bob McClure got away fifth and were on the move entering the backstretch. That move would send Beach Glass and driver Paul MacDonell out of the two-hole to come around, but the lead change wasn't without some battle.





After hitting the half in :55, Beach Glass would be overtaken by Stonebridge Helios, who led by the third-marker in 1:23. The top-two would engage in a battle down the lane, but it was Magical Arthur that got the last laugh, powering by on the outside to win by half a length over Beach Glass in 1:50.3. Stonebridge Helios was third, while Frozen Hanover was fourth.

Reply here.

A gelded son of Artspeak, Magical Arthur was winless in three starts this season prior to Saturday's race. The homebred for David Lumsden now has four wins and \$271,453 in earnings.

"Tonight, he had a chance to race and he proved he's as good as them," said Henry of Magical Arthur. "They are two nice horses and I thought I could get up for second, Bobby (McClure) was pecking at (Stonebridge Helios) at the head of the stretch and I thought I might get second, but I didn't really think I could beat (Beach Glass), but he did."

Magical Arthur paid \$13.90 to win.

Both of Saturday's Somebeachsomewhere division winners are eligible to the Pepsi North America Cup.

GRADUATE SERIES RETURNS TO MOHAWK

The Graduate Series made its first appearance at Woodbine Mohawk Park since 2019 on Saturday. The 4-year-old series featured four divisions, two for the ladies and two for the boys.

Oakwoodanabella (IR) got full respect and made no mistake on the front to win the first \$50,000 division for pacing mares. Todd McCarthy grabbed his second stakes win of the evening, guiding the 1/5 favourite to victory for trainer Brian Brown.

The Irish bred Oakwoodanabella (IR) posted fractions of :27.1, :55.2 and 1:22.4 before pacing home in :27.3 for her third win in four starts this season. Fire Start Hanover finished second by 2 ¼ lengths in her season debut. Awesome Hill was third, while Scarlett Hanover was fourth.

A daughter of Foreclosure, Oakwoodanabella (IR) arrived in North America last August and has now won eight of 13 starts. Her Graduate division win boosts her season earnings to \$53,250 for owner Denis Copse.

"I think she's going to get better, especially next year," said Brown. "We'll stick with the 4-year-olds as much as we can. She has some of the races with the older mares. I didn't come here to the Roses Are Red, the Milton I think I'm in that... she's just 4 and I didn't want to overdo it too early in the year."

Oakwoodanabella paid \$2.50 to win.

Bulldog Hanover made a second-quarter move to the top and never looked back to win the first \$62,500 Graduate division in 1:49.2. The Jack Darling trainee went third to first for driver Jody Jamieson, pacing by the half in :55.3 and three-quarters in 1:23 before shooting home in :26.2.

"I just thought I'd get to the front as early as possible and get the traffic out of the way," said Jamieson. "He's just such a great horse and I knew it was no problem getting to the lead and even if we had to race a little bit for it, it was going to be on, but it wasn't and he won pretty handily."

Making his Woodbine season debut, Bulldog Hanover is now two for three this season. The son of Shadow Play won 10 of 15 starts last season and Saturday's 16th career victory pushes him to the brink of millionaire status.

Jack Darling Stables Limited and Brad Grant share ownership of 'Bulldog', who paid \$5.70 to win.

Carbine showed tremendous grit to pull out a 1:49 victory in the second \$62,500 Graduate division. Todd McCarthy scored his third stakes win of the evening by guiding the Tony Alagna trainee to victory.

After posting a :26.3 opening-quarter, Carbine received company in the form of a first-up attack from favourite Linedrive Hanover, who came out from fifth. The half was reached in :54.3 and then a third-quarter slugfest ensued between Carbine and 'Linedrive', which saw the pacers duel by the third-marker in 1:21.1.

In the stretch, Carbine dug deep to hold the lead right to the wire, fighting off three rivals for the victory. One Eight Hundred got up for second on the far outside, while Bettors Donttell pushed up the rail to be third. Linedrive Hanover stayed in the fight, finishing fourth.

Fittingly a son of Somebeachsomewhere, Carbine improved to three for four on the season and now has 10 victories and over \$139,000 earned for owners Let It Ride Stables Inc., Bottom Line Racing LLC and Howard Taylor.

Carbine paid \$6 to win.

The Graduate Series resumes with the third leg on June 25 at The Meadowlands. The finals will take place on July 9 at The Meadowlands.

IN THE MOOD UPSETS IN 3YOFT OSS GOLD OPENER

The opening Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Leg for 3-year-old pacing fillies took place Saturday (June 4) at Woodbine Mohawk Park, and Shawn Steacy trained filly **In The Mood** was ready for an upset, winning the \$199,900 division in 1:50.3 after going off at 14-1.

Leaving from post six Sylvain Filion piloted In The Mood, a daughter of Sunshine Beach, into third position at the half, sitting off a :55 pace set by 2021 O'Brien Award finalist Silver Label (Bettors Delight), who was taken to the to the front by Mark MacDonald from post 10.

"With the two big favorites drawing the 10 and 11, I knew that made it so you had to be close to the front," said Steacy. "And the six hole is just about the perfect spot to leave from."

Silver Label was overtaken by her Nick Gallucci and Millar Farms stablemate Prohibition Legal, the odds-on favourite, heading into the stretch before In The Mood blasted to the front in

the deep stretch, pacing the last quarter mile in :26.3 to win by a length.

"She's just like a little sports car," said Steacy. "She can just zip off the wing and give a good punch coming home, and that's exactly how it worked out.

It was the first OSS win at the Gold level for In The Mood, owned by Steacy's parents and Hudson Standrdbrd.

"To win a big Sires Stakes division, and have my parent own a piece of the filly and one of our biggest owners, how can you not say it's exciting," said Steacy.

In The Mood made one start last year at the Gold level, and then dropped to the Grassroots, where she won two divisions, and finished fourth in the Grassroots Championships.

"It's shaping up so she should be a player throughout the year in the Golds," said Steacy. "She's such a smart filly. She takes care of herself really well, and she's really sound. I think that's what's going to make her last throughout the year

Prohibition Legal, driven by James MacDonald finished second, the first OSS defeat for the Big Jim filly.

Louis-Philippe Roy drove Love That Smile to round out the topthree, the fourth career on the board OSS finish for the daughter of Sportswriter. She now has over \$166,000 in career earnings for owners M&s Racing Stable, Gilles Caouette, Marc Gelinas, and Rene Bourassa.

Federal judge in Kentucky dismisses lawsuit challenging the constitutionality of HISA

A federal judge in Kentucky on Friday (June 3) dismissed a lawsuit brought by the State of Oklahoma and several other plaintiffs, including the United States Trotting Association, that challenged the constitutionality of the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Act (HISA).

Judge Joseph M. Hood of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Kentucky held against the plaintiffs on their constitutional claims but ruled in the plaintiffs' favor in regard to justiciability, confirming that the plaintiffs are proper parties to assert their constitutional claims in federal court.

If an appeal to Judge Hood's decision is filed, it would be heard by the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, located in Cincinnati, Ohio.

He's unbelievable. Once they straighten up [in the stretch], he'll give you everything he's got."

Sent to the gate as the 9-1 fourth choice in the wagering, Corey Callahan asked JL Cruze for his usual early speed, and the veteran provided just that, leading the seven-horse field past the quarter in :28.2 before rating the half back to a sleepy :58.

Cindy Michelle then came calling using a burst of speed around the far turn, and she towed 2-1 second choice Fast As The Wind into the race as the pocket-sitting even-money favorite, Delayed Hanover, was the recipient of a perfect trip.

Through the stretch, Cindy Michelle kept the heat on after actually getting a head up at the top of the lane, leaving Delayed Hanover no place to race as Fast As The Wind tipped off his cover and made a late charge at the leader, but at the wire, it was JL Cruze, aka "The King", hanging on by a nose in 1:53.2. Fast As The Wind was second with Cindy Michelle third and Delayed Hanover fourth.

"Believe it or not, he's as sound now as I've had him his whole career," said Ell. "I still don't like putting him on a five-eighths mile track as it lames him up. He's had many lameness issues throughout his career, but he is sound right now. Father time is catching up to him as far as soundness. I would love to get him to \$2 million [in lifetime earnings], but it gets tougher every year."

The first horse to ever break the 1:50 barrier on the trot at The Meadowlands with a 1:49.4 clocking seven years ago, JL Cruze paid \$20.20 to win. He now has 48 victories from 162 lifetime

starts, good for earnings of \$1,710,387 for owners W. Kenneth Wood, WJ. Dittmar and S.J. laquinta.

BROWER A 'MASTERMIND': In the first round of the "Battle of The Meadowlands Masterminds", Dave Brower cashed three of his four wins bets and turned his \$500 bankroll into \$1,030 by night's end.

The competition pits Big M handicappers in a contest where one lucky fan can walk away with \$10,000 on Hambletonian Day. In addition, all five track touts are playing for charities that will get a donation regardless of where their handicapper finishes at the conclusion of the contest.

Dave Little went three-for-five and hit a pair of trifectas to walk away with \$845.40. Ken Warkentin was next with \$321, followed by Jessica Otten and Edison Hatter, who cashed in for \$200 each.
