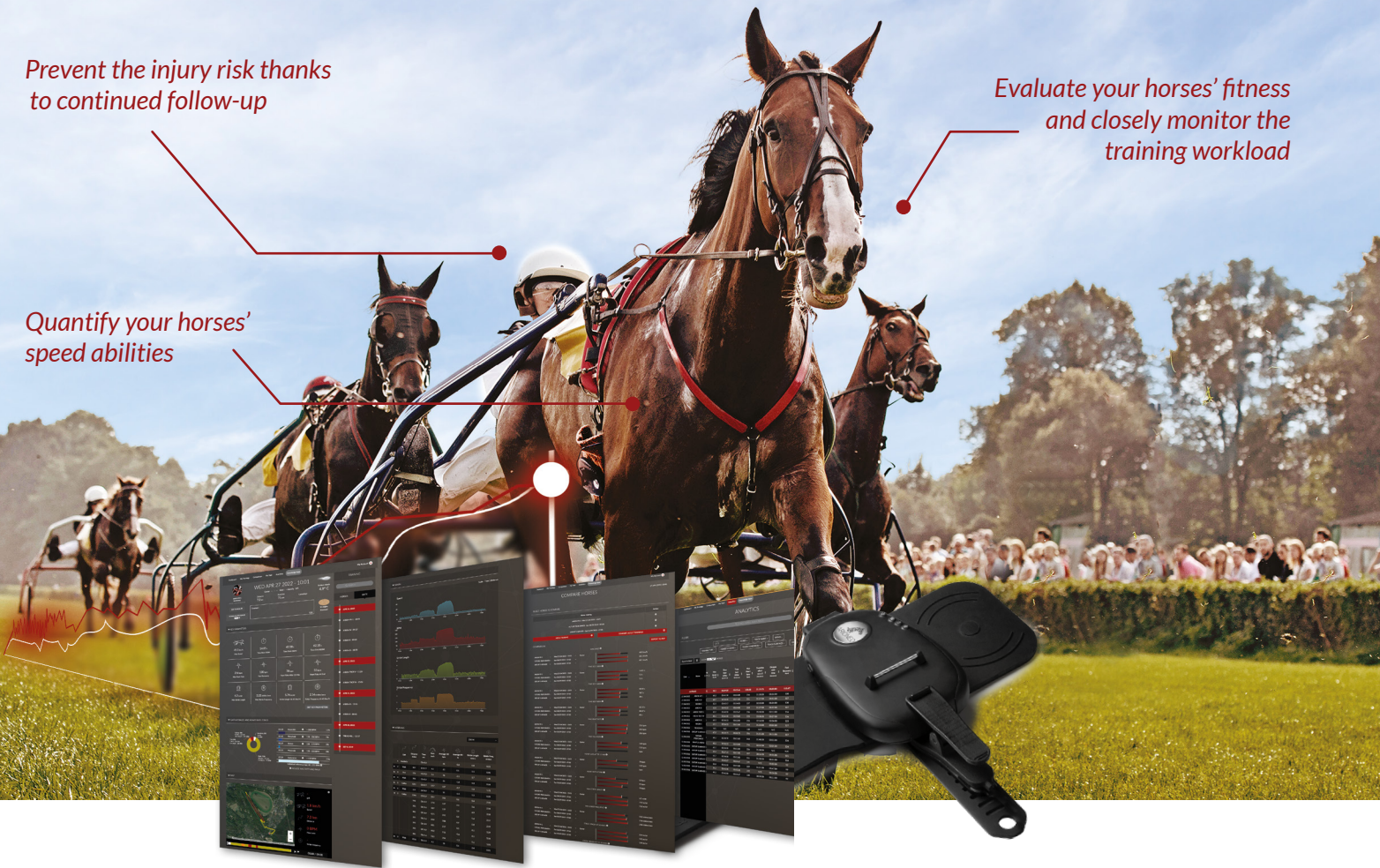

These types of institutions are a building block for creating success, whether in golf, or in history.

In the late 1700's, we all know the Industrial Revolution began in England. Why this new way of doing things took place in England and not in other rich and vibrant countries like Holland or Spain is a question that economists have been studying for many years.

They believe one of the major reasons England was home to massive innovation, was due to their institutions. Private property rights were respected by a rule of law, innovations were protected and diffused freely, a strong educational system fed the funnels, and organizations like the Royal Society were incubators that allowed science to flourish.

Frankly, this has been a feature in almost everything that grows.

In harness racing it's no secret we've never had such a structure. If we had a nickel for the times we've heard the sport clamouring for a commissioner, we'd have enough nickels to fund the next 50 Hambletonians.

What we have had – state commissions, the USTA, Hambletonian Society, horsepeople groups – have certainly not done poorly. Particularly, in terms of forwarding the rent-seeking behavior of our sport (for example, slots), I think they've been effective, and this demands praise. But bringing people together like a PGA Tour or 1800 England? It just simply has not been in their wheelhouse. And that's been, in my view, one of this sport's biggest problems.

This is a sport where the owner of the highest handle track in the world has to send email and text blasts to get entries. It's where those seeking uniform rules are met with quizzical stares. It's where the same group of buyers attend yearling sales, buying horses to be trained by the same half-dozen people. It's an entity where it seems there are a dozen PGA Tours fighting each other; sometimes for what purpose, we do not know.

What sport with strong institutional power – pick one – would allow any of that to happen?

There's some strong negative opinion on HISA, and I hear it loud and clear. In fact, I agree with some of it. But what HISA does have going for it may be necessary for a sport devoid of national, institutional leadership.

I think that's why many people – in shedrows, on these pages, or in grandstands – want to give it a chance. No one else has stepped up to the plate who can take charge; to address things that an MLB or NHL or PGA Tour would've long addressed. This sport is begging for institutional leadership, and white hat or black hat, on a hill or in the valley, they're the only one standing.

A conversation with Alan Katz of the 3 Brothers Stable

If one were looking to use one word to describe the entity known as 3 Brothers Stable, that word likely would be family. One could say that the stable began in 1978 when the members of the family, the parents Jack and Pearl Katz, together with their three sons Ronnie, Steve and Alan, made a visit to one of the premier New York breeding farms of that era, Pine Hollow Stud at the invitation of the farm's owner Morty Finder. Their goal was to look into the possibility of getting into horse ownership. They had been harness racing fans for quite some time. Jack and Pearl thought that it might be fun to match their interest in racing with owning a horse or two that they could cheer on. It was there that they met Bob Boni who was working at Pine Hollow at the time. It's a relationship that has certainly stood the test of time, one related to both friendship and business.

The Katz family had become fans of the sport in that era through their attendance at Monticello Raceway and the city racetracks Roosevelt and Yonkers. It was a totally different time than it is today. The Catskills were a very popular destination for New Yorkers who spent their vacations and sometimes their entire summers in the resorts and bungalows in the area to escape from the sometimes blistering heat of New York City in summer. For those families, it was not unusual for the breadwinner to come north to the Catskills with his family for the summer season. He would spend his weekends with the family before returning to the city to presumably earn enough to be able to pay for this indulgence. The remainder of the family would usually remain for the rest of the week enjoying the amenities available at or near the resort. There were all sorts of things that one could do to fill a busy schedule. Among them were attendance at nearby Monticello Raceway. The Katzes had long been fans of harness racing in New York City, often attending at Roosevelt and Yonkers Raceways.

Here they were with a chance to have direct participation in a sport which they enjoyed.

They ended up buying two Fulla Napoleon yearlings Dr Zweig and Juke Box from Pine Hollow.

Their first trainer was Michigan native Mike Harding.

Neither of their purchases was the champion that most owners dream of, especially new ones. They both ended up being adequate racehorses.

They were excited.

This scribe spoke Alan, the youngest of the three Katz brothers, to traverse the time involved in the sport by he and his family.

Q: Your family have been involved in harness racing for a very long time. How has it evolved?

"We all would go to Yonkers and Roosevelt in the city and Monticello in the summers. We really enjoyed going to the track before we ever became involved as owners. We've been privileged to have made many friends throughout the time we've been in the sport. We all love it, but we have had varying degrees of interest through the years. In the formative years, my mom was the most interested. Of we three brothers, I would say that my late brother Steven and I were the most involved, with the eldest Ronnie being somewhat less so. Actually Ronnie's wife Mardi is the one who today probably has the greatest connection with the horses themselves. That, I guess, isn't that much different from the formative years when my mom was the one who enjoyed interacting with our horses. She would spoil them terribly with carrots and candy. I suppose that she might be the genesis of us getting involved with the breeding of them. She built a relationship with horses, especially the fillies. When their usefulness as racehorses expired she wouldn't want to let go. So we evolved into breeding them."

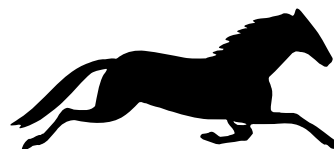

Q: You are involved with both breeding and racing. Which do you prefer?

"They both have their good and sometimes not so good aspects. There is nothing comparable to breeding and raising a horse and seeing it achieve tremendous success. We were privileged to have done so with JK Shesalady and JK Endofanera. From only a handful of mares raising a Horse of the Year and a divisional champion. Both these two are on their way to possible greatness in the next stage of their careers. JK Endofanera its already one of the most successful stallions in Indiana and JK Shesalady's first two foals are the multiple stakes winning fillies JK First Lady(\$879,136) and JK Alwaysbalady(\$244,356). The other side of that story is that we were the breeder (with George Segal) of Mr Musclemann who earned well over \$3 million and who we sold as a yearling for all of \$1,900. I suppose that goes to prove that in the yearling game you can't judge a book by its cover. Mr Musclemann was a big, gangly colt as a yearling. There was nothing seriously wrong with him other than his being somewhat immature.

Q: How do you primarily look at yourselves, as owners of racehorses or as breeders?

"Without a doubt as owners. We love owning racehorses, especially, of course, good ones. On the other hand, based

upon our experience last year, I'm reconsidering. What we have normally done when it comes time to make a decision as to whether we keep our yearlings to train and race or sell them in the yearling sales, we have Bob Boni evaluate them and we make our decision based on that evaluation. Last year things were difficult. My brother Steven was terminally ill and too much was going on. I told the farms where they were to enter them in the sales and that we likely would make the decisions when we saw them at the sales. They were a nice group. We decided to take our chances and let them go into the sales ring. They were all sold and every one brought more than we anticipated. In any event, the yearling game isn't an easy one. You try to gather as much information as you possibly can on them. But the one thing you cannot do is look inside of them and tell how much heart, speed and determination they are going to have."

Q: What has changed the most since you folks started in 1978?

"I would say just about everything and very little of it for the better, except for the purses. Except that even there, the purses haven't risen commensurate with the costs of doing business. Everything has gone up: training, shipping, vet bills, you name it. It is to the point that unless you've got that great horse, your chances of making money are not too good. On the other hand, you've got the puzzle of last year's yearling sales. The prices

were out of the ballpark. It used to be, and that was not too long ago, that you could buy just about any top pacing filly for a \$100,000 or thereabouts. Last year, they were often opening at that price point and rising. How can person even dream of making money on a pacing filly that costs half a million?

"One thing I believe that has hurt us enormously is having the stable areas of many racetracks shuttered. Not only has it raised the cost of doing business a whole lot, but it has also affected owner participation greatly. It used to be that going to the track on a Saturday morning was an event to look forward too. It fostered friendships and good times. Today, it is fairly rare to see owners at the training centers and even attending the races to see their horses race."

Q: Where do you see the business five or 10 years from now?

"I wish I could say otherwise, but I fear for its future, perhaps not in that time frame, but I find trouble in imagining it being healthy. In my opinion, there are two main factors. The first is the cost of doing business as we've discussed. The second and possibly the most damaging is the age of our participants. Whether you are speaking of those going to the track or those buying horses, it has become a game for old folks. Look at our leaders, Jeff Gural, George Segal, Jules Siegel and some others. They are octogenarians. There are many others older than 70. Those who we haven't replaced for several generations. Aside from people like Adam Bowden and Steve Jones' two sons, the younger generation today has very little and in most instances no knowledge of us. The main thing that created the most interest in my generation was the thrill of going to the racetrack, the thrill of picking a winner and the ability to share that excitement with those who went to the track with you. Today, the vast majority of the money bet on horses comes from outside the track, probably in most instances from somebody sitting from behind a desk looking at a computer screen."

Q: What does 3 Brothers Stables' horse inventory look like today?

"Presently, we are involved with 10 racehorses— by racehorses I mean 2- and 3-year-olds), eight broodmares, six yearlings and eight sucklings. We keep most of our mares at Hanover. We do have three mares and their foals in Kentucky to take advantage of the new Kentucky stakes programs. That is a great incentive for the industry. I have great confidence in Dr. J (Bridgette Jablonsky) at Hanover. She does a great job. This breeding season we bred our mares to Captaintreachorous, Papi Rob Hanover, Perfect Sting and our own JK Endofanera and Captain Crunch."

Q: For an entity that has been in the business as long as you folks, you have had relatively few trainers.

"We've always prided ourselves on our loyalty. If a trainer treats us well we are going to treat that person likewise. We started with Mike Harding, we then had George Berkner who the whole family loved, then to Linda Toscano, Nancy Takter, Ronnie Burke and Brett Pelling. Today we have horses with Linda, Nancy, Brett and Ronnie."

Q: You've mentioned your disappointment with the racing situation at The Meadowlands.

"I strongly believe that The Meadowlands is still our greatest track. I believe that Jeff Gural wants to and usually does do what is best for the sport. I don't want to blame anybody for what is happening there with regard to amateur races. However, having five amateur races on a Saturday night at our greatest track is an embarrassment — for the track itself and for

the sport. I don't blame Jeff. However, I believe the situation can be improved upon with some imagination shown by the racing office. Certain things could be improved upon. How about carding more races for 3-year-olds, especially 3-year-old pacers, both colts and fillies. What about considering some claiming races for 3-year-old pacers? Not only carding them but going to the trainers whose stables they are in. All these suggestions might not work, but they certainly are worth trying.

The COVID situation has affected us somewhat but not as hard as it has hurt other businesses. Thus far, we've been fortunate enough to keep on going on."

I know this is a reach, but as great a racehorse as Noble was, he was inbred 2 by 4 to Volomite, and he had less-than-perfect fertility. I think that with his potency, Noble Victory passed on to Valley Victory's dam his limited fertility gene, and she passed it on to her son Valley Victory.

When one is dealing with questions involving standardbreds, there is always an answer to be found, if one only looks hard enough. Which is why a racehorse will invariably improve after being checked and worked on by a top vet, i.e. a Dr. Melissa McKee, and a Dr. Jennifer Stowe.

At 85, it is time to be in earnest

After running literally hundreds and hundreds of five-generation pedigrees, I know with certainty that there is virtually no inbreeding within the American standardbred at this point in time.

That means we will see no fertility loss as the current racing stars leave the track and enter the stud. That has not always been the case. While the American pacer has never in the past 50 years paid any price for close breeding, the American trotter did.

The technical term that describes that problem is a loss of heterozygosity, the variability factor. The most notable stallion who suffered under the burden of limited fertility was Valley Victory. Despite small foal crops, VV sired three Hambletonian winners and numerous other tip stakes winners.

Yet, when one looks at V²'s five generation pedigree, there is no answer to be seen there, because there is no close breeding. The closest thing to an answer I can supply is through his second dam, Victorious Lou.

She's a daughter of Noble Victory, the first million-dollar standardbred when I syndicated him in 1966. Vic was a great racehorse. Trained by Stanley Dancer, his only failure came in the Hambletonian, which he came to as the overwhelming favorite. However, it had rained buckets the day before, and the clay track at DuQuoin was like glue. Noble couldn't handle the heavy going, although he did make his best showing when he finished third in the third heat as the track was staring to dry.

The ultimate winner that day was Noble's stablemate, Egyptian Candor. Del Cameron drove him wearing a pair of blue pants Dancer had given him that day. After Cameron won the Hambletonian in his new blue pants, Dancer swore Cameron didn't take them off for the next three weeks.

Having said all this, there is always an exception that proves the rule. In this case I found it when I printed out the five generation pedigree of Instagram Model.

She's a 2-year-old filly who sold for \$350,000 last fall as a yearling. She caught my eye because she just won her first baby race in 2:20.3.1. Which leaves a lot of open water between that race and \$350,000 plus, but every journey starts with the first step.

Instagram Model is inbred, 3 by 3, because on her Tail-Male side Conway Hall is her great grandsire, and on the bottom, on the Tail-Mare, we have Conway Hall's full sister, Emilie Cas El, in the third generation.

Both of these names resonate with me, since Meg and I bred Conway Hall and Emilie Cas El, who was only the second 2-year-old to be voted Horse of the Year in Canada and was a major reason I bought her sire, Garland Lobell.

Here, a note regarding how stallions are properly handled. When I went up to Quebec to take an up-close and personal look at Garland, he was in the middle of a barn full of mares.

Being a know-it-all in the horse business, when I syndicated Garland, I just put him into the famous Walnut Hall stud barn. If it was good enough for Scotland and Volomite, of course it was good enough for Garland.

Except that it wasn't. As long as he was stabled within sight and sound of other studs, he didn't breed as well as he had in Quebec, surrounded only by his harem.

Now I think it's common knowledge that every stallion will breed better if he's only exposed to mares, both in his stabling and when turned out. Well, maybe I shouldn't put it that way, because I know there are some big operators in our biz who keep all their studs in the same barn, and turn them out in the adjacent paddocks.

MEA CULPA

Finally, a huge Mea Culpa for [what I wrote](#) two weeks ago about the great thoroughbred stallion Mr. Prospector. Obviously I had the wrong horse, for which I am profoundly sorry.

The man who put me in my place was **Dr. Douglas Koch**, of Berkshire Stud, in Pine Plains, NY. I have been going bonkers trying to reach Dr. Koch, whose listed number no longer rings through.

He's totally right that I was totally wrong attributing that hard luck story to Mr. Prospector. But I know what I wrote does correctly apply to another thoroughbred stallion, and I thought Dr. Koch could supply me with the correct name.

Again, here, I'm guided by Dr. Samuel Johnson, viz;

"At eight-five, it is time to be in earnest."

Racing her horses mostly at Marquis Downs (Saskatoon) and Calgary (Century Downs), Kanak is setting her eyes on soon racing at Winnipeg (The Loop).

"Racing for the Robert Smith Stable in Saskatoon I had West Coast Beach and Spark the Dragon. Racing the small circuit in Saskatoon is a completely different environment than racing in Calgary (where Bud Smith Has Mystic Dragon and See You Tonight.)

Sparky (Spark The Dragon) had his first two career wins in early May, shortly after we bought him. Mystic Dragon just came in after a few weeks of turn out, so I'm excited to get him back jogging and training as we prepare for the move to Winnipeg.

"Harness racing has become my world and I couldn't be happier. Racing, along with most equine sports, demands a lot from the horses. When the horses race their hearts out for me, I try to give that same effort back to them.

"I'm told that my horses are spoiled, but in reality I'm the one who is spoiled. I try to repay my horses for the joy that they bring into my life through their daily care, enrichment, and by giving them lots and lots of treats.

Perfectly timing the races for maximum benefit

"Tatum dribbles at the top of the key. Sixteen seconds remain on the clock in the third quarter. The Celtics will play for the last shot."

My mental stopwatch is activated. I tap the mute button on my remote and rise.

I command, "Hey Google, play John Cougar Mellencamp." When Cherry Bomb begins to play, I whistle to my dog, Franklin. He romps over, and I open the backyard screen door. Franklin does his business in the bushes near the woods and follows me into the kitchen for ear scratching and treats from the kitchen counter. Next, I turn on the kitchen faucet, squirt a dab of soap into the basin, drop a few cups and glasses into the suds and use the Brillo Pad on the ones that need a little help. Leaving them to soak, I dry my hands on a towel. Then I head out the front door to the mailbox. On my return, I toss the junk mail into the trash and the bills on the kitchen table. I check my phone messages and text Wally back that I am in for good to go for the Friday tee time.

I flop into my recliner, ask Goggle to turn off the music, and press unmute button on the remote. Like a coordinated ballet, the graphics and introductory music from the basketball game telecast fades, and the ball gets inbound. The total time between the mute and the unmute is four minutes and one second.

We all play the game of multitasking during commercial breaks. You can accomplish many tasks and tomfoolery if you are a good player. Once, I repainted a bedroom during a playoff football game. During the first commercial break, I dragged out the furniture. I know a guy with a big yard who cuts his lawn during commercial segments.

Viewers increasingly check their ever-present phones for texts and emails during commercial breaks and intermission of sporting events. They use the time to make a sandwich, play solitaire, wash the car, talk to their spouse or significant other, scroll through the two hundred available stations, or watch snippets of another game.

I am betting that a few of you do an odd version of the digital break dance. During a commercial break of a major sporting event, you grab your iPad and click onto your favorite harness racetrack. *If* a harness race is close to a race starting, you play a race during a commercial break from the big game. The suggestion is that there should be no *if* in the previous sentence. A race should always be waiting.

Racetracks should carefully coordinate the start time of harness races with the major sporting events.

The racetrack does not need permission or contracts. They do not need to do anything but slightly adjust the starting time to increase business. There would be no downside, and this business practice would add extra money to the wagering pools. If non-racing fans find us in the coordinated interlude, that would be wonderful.

We have a few assets in horseracing. Two of those unique assets are that a horserace only takes a few minutes, and the racetrack has wiggle room for exactly when we start our races.

This minimal adjustment in starting time would seem simple. An NBA playoff game, a World Series game, or a Stanley Cup game draws millions of eyes. Many of those eyes, perhaps even yours, search for other places for their attention during commercial breaks.

Why not have a harness race become one of those landing places.

A spotter at the track predicts the next sizeable commercial bank will begin in three minutes, at 2:46, and this is the cue for the post parade. The horses continue to warm up on the track until the next signal, precisely ten seconds after the national commercial bank begins, the race announcer or television host announces, "You have one minute to post time. One minute, get those wagers in."

The transition should be seamless for me sitting at home, for any horse race gambler, or any newbie to the horserace gambling site that we can stir up. A commercial begins, one quick click to the racing site, the race starts in less than one minute, slip in a wager, watch the race, watch the replay, and click back to the national game just as the action resumes.

We should carefully tailor our product so that every commercial break of a big game is our window, friend, and opportunity. Four minutes to grab eyes and money. This alteration should not alienate our current audience. The exchange of a slightly altered post time for more stupid money in the pools should be a blessing.

In 2022, viewers multi-task during commercials. A quick race and a quick bet can be one of those tasks. This evening, I played two races that ACCIDENTALLY that happened to be close to approaching the start gate during commercial breaks of the national baseball telecast. I would have lost more money if ingenious personnel at the racetrack PURPOSELY had coordinated the starting gate with the commercial breaks.

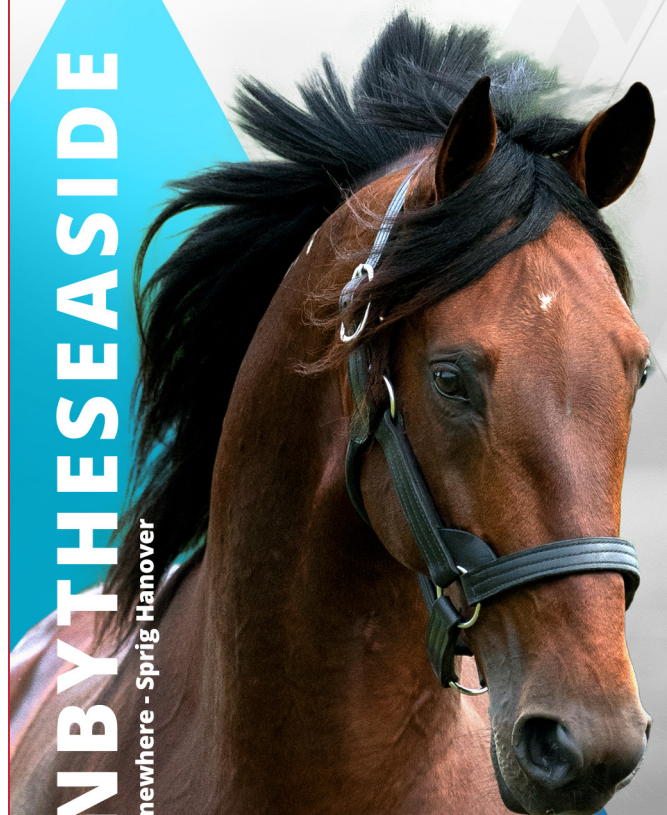

Pebble Beach shores up résumé with emphatic Pepsi North America Cup win

Record handle night for Woodbine Mohawk Park of \$6.3 million, highlighted by \$1.9 million in new money wagered on the Jackpot Hi-5 mandatory payout.

Pebble Beach might not have heard the roar of the crowd, but a primetime performance spoke volumes of his talent in a brilliant \$1 million Pepsi North America Cup showing, Saturday night June 18 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The decision by driver Todd McCarthy not to pop the earplugs down the lane showed just how much confidence he had in his speedy bay colt.

It certainly wasn't an ideal start for Pebble Beach (Downbytheseaside—Santa Rosa), the 2-5 choice in the 39th edition of the Cup, as McCarthy found himself with an early choice to make as the field made its way into the first turn.

Frozen Hanover, a son of the legendary Somebeachsomewhere, crossed over from post nine to seize the lead, as Cup elim winner Beach Glass, also a son Somebeachsomewhere, settled into second. Unable to find a spot along the rail, Pebble Beach continued to press on from the outside as the field reached the opening quarter in :27.3.

McCarthy and the Noel Daley trainee glided up beside the pacesetter, eventually seizing command just before a half in :55, a length in front of Beach Glass, with Frozen Hanover sitting third and I Did It Myway fourth.

Reaching three quarters in 1:22.3, Pebble Beach came off the turn full of pace, a confident McCarthy sitting chilly on a cool southwestern Ontario Saturday evening, as the duo began to dash away with ease from their rivals.

Late in the stretch, it was simply a case of what the winning the margin would be and who would round out the next spots on the tote board.

“I would have liked the idea of being able to get in early and make the decision to move, but our hand got forced there and I had to keep pressing,” said McCarthy. A :55 [half]... I was pretty happy with that. I just had to look after him from there and I knew he would have a big last quarter for me. He was terrific.”

Daley had equally high praise for his speedster.

“It wasn’t where I thought we were going to be, but they were going easy fractions. I left it to Todd to make his decision there and he did the right thing. As you see, he still has his earplugs in, so he wasn’t too worried about it. He showed now he’s got a bit of versatility — he can do it in front or behind.”

For driver and trainer, their first Cup appearances proved to be the charm.

Daley trained 2010 Cup finalist All Speed Hanover. However, he sent the horse to conditioner Mike Vanderkemp for the Cup. He finished 10th in the final after winning his elimination. McCarthy was making his Cup debut in just his third season racing in North America. He followed the lead of his older brother Andy and relocated to America from Australia in the second half of 2020.

Saturday, Daley and McCarthy were the dynamic duo with a dynamic sophomore star bred by Brittany Farms.

“It’s so surreal,” said McCarthy, on his way over to the winner’s circle. “I’m speechless. I can’t thank Noel enough for what he’s

done for me since I’ve come over here too. He was a large part in helping me come over and to win this race with him has just been unbelievable. I was lucky enough to pick up this horse early on and he’s just been an absolute pleasure.”

Daley, primarily known for his success with trotters, added a new chapter to his racing repertoire.

“It’s probably our biggest win,” said Daley. “Mr Musclemans won a million-dollar race [the 2003 \$1.3 million Canadian Trotting

Classic] up here. It's good to have a pacer. I've never won a big race with a pacer like this."

Originally an \$85,000 purchase (Hip No. 710) at the 2020 Lexington Select Sale, Pebble Beach didn't hear the adulation and applause in the final quarter of his journey but was every bit deserving of it all.

Now a 10-time winner, along with three seconds and two thirds from 15 starts, Pebble Beach paid \$3.10 for the win. He is owned by Patricia Stable, Joe Sbrocco, Country Club Acres Inc., and Laexpressfoderadeovolente.

The evening's second race, the Milton District Hospital Foundation (@MDH_Foundation) trot, was won by multiple stakes champion Forbidden Trade.

Saturday evening's Pepsi North America Cup card established a new Pepsi North America Cup handle record of \$6.3 million, besting the \$5.6 million handle in 2020. The handle was headlined by \$1.9 million in new money wagered on the Jackpot Hi-5 mandatory payout.

Fast As The Wind, with Dexter Dunn in the race bike, flew home to win the \$251,000 Goodtimes Stakes on Saturday evening (June 18) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Sent on his way as the 2-5 choice in the Goodtimes, Fast As The Wind arrived at his latest test off a stellar three-length win one week earlier in his elimination engagement.

On this night, he was even more impressive.

It was Looks Like Moni who assumed early command, crossing over from post eight to strike front into the first turn, with Southwind Domino and Pretender settling into second and third, respectively, as Dunn settled Fast As The Wind in fourth.

Looks Like Moni called the shots through a brisk opening quarter in :27.2, and was still on top through as :55.1, as Dunn held a patient hand, sitting fourth, but well within striking distance of the pacesetter.

After three quarters reached in 1:23.1, Looks Like Moni, with Andrew McCarthy in the sulky, broke stride around the turn for home, opening the door for the trio of hard-closing Twin B Archie, a game Pretender and surging Fast As The Wind to battle for top prize.

Living up to his name, Fast As The Wind reeled in his rivals in deep stretch, carving out a final quarter of :28.2 to cross the wire a 1 ¾-length winner in a lifetime best 1:52.2. Twin B Archie was second, Pretender finished third and Testing Testing rallied to secure fourth.

“He was running in a touch coming off that last turn and I had to nurse him there,” said Dunn. “Once Andy’s one made a break, it got us a little closer to the front there, and he laid down like he has been this year. He’s definitely going in the right direction. He’s doing everything right and hasn’t put in a foot wrong so far. He’s finishing his races off really strongly.”

Trained by Tony Alagna for the ownership group of Leblanc and Kribbs, Joe Sbrocco, and Joseph Barbera, the son of Cantab Hall—Wind Stroll now has two wins, one second and a third form four starts on the season. Overall, the bay colt is 7-2-4 from 18 starts.

The trotter’s upcoming dance card could include a date in the Hambletonian on Aug. 6.

Bred by Tony Holmes, Fast As The Wind was a \$95,000 purchase (Hip No. 202) at the 2020 Lexington Select Sale.

He paid \$2.90 for his Goodtimes victory. The race presentation was made by John Bax, who campaigned world champion and Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame inductee Goodtimes to a 50-win career and over \$2.2 million in lifetime earnings.

Pelling girls 1-2 in Fan Hanover final

Trainer Brett Pelling sent out a pair of talented 3-year-old pacing fillies, **Treacherous Dragon** and Wickedly Innocent, in Saturday's (June 18) \$401,000 Fan Hanover final at Woodbine Mohawk Park and the pair picked up 75 per cent of the purse with an exciting one-two finish.

As the race got underway, last week's elimination winner Silver Label battled Queen Of Success for the early lead and prevailed to take the group by the opening marker in :26.4. As they paced to the half it was Sea Silk up to grab the front and she hit that marker in :55.

Silver Label's stablemate Prohibition Legal popped out from fourth and began her assault towing Treacherous Dragon, the other elimination winner, with her. Prohibition Legal cleared by the three-quarters in 1:22 but down the stretch Treacherous Dragon and Tim Tetrick went on by and held off her late charging stablemate, Wickedly Innocent, to win in 1:50.1.

Ontario-bred fillies Prohibition Legal and Silver Label, both Millar Farms homebreds trained by Nick Gallucci, were third and fourth, respectively. Boudoir Hanover closed a ton to take the final cheque.

The winner has some family history with this race as her dam, the top race filly My Little Dragon, finished a close second in the 2006 edition of the race. Treacherous Dragon is the ninth foal of the mare who won \$2.3 million in her career.

Bred by White Birch Farm of NJ, and owned by Hot Lead Farm of Allentown, Treacherous Dragon is a daughter of 2013 NA Cup winner Captaintreacherous and Tetrick noted the filly reminds him a lot of her sire.

A \$260,000 yearling, Treacherous Dragon upped her career earnings over the \$575,000 mark with tonight's effort. A winner of four of 10 last season, she is undefeated thus far at 3 with tonight's win being her fifth in as many tries.

"I did not want to be on the front (given the windy conditions)," said Tetrick. "I had the trip I wanted. Brett has done a great job with this filly, he's brought her along slow. He is great at what he does and setting them up for the 3-year-old year. He's got this mare in form, and hopefully he gets to keep her that way for the next weeks."

"They're both really strong fillies, they're very efficient," said Pelling. "(Treacherous Dragon) is very calm and stoic, nothing fazes her too much."

The Fan Hanover was established in 1983 to honour one of the greatest pacing mares of all time and still the only female to ever win the coveted Little Brown Jug. A member of the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame, Fan Hanover was purchased as a yearling and owned through the remainder of her life by fellow Hall of Famer Dr. Glen Brown one of the most respected administrators in harness racing and a long-time director of WEG. Dr. Brown presented the Fan Hanover trophy to the race's winner for many years. He died last month at 88.

"She's incredible, as she gets older, you appreciate her even more. She's so game and does her job week in and week out. She deserves the big ones. Ron Burke does a tremendous job bringing horses back year after year after year. I can't praise him enough," said Gingras.

"You can do whatever you want with her, you can leave or go back to last. She hasn't been as good as perhaps in years past, I wanted to spot her and hope for the best from there. We got a good trip, it worked out perfect tonight."

Atlanta has competed in the last four Armbro Flights winning back in her first appearance in 2019, also with Yannick at the controls. That time of 1:50.2 was a Canadian and stakes record.

The event is named in honor of one of the greatest trotting mares bred in Canada. Armbro Flight, inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in 1976, was Canada's Horse of the year for three straight years in the mid-1960s. Her legacy still lives on in trotting families across North America.

Fire Start Hanover took second while Gias Surreal held on for third. Kobes Gigi and last year's Roses Are Red winner Lyons Sentinel grabbed the last checks.

Although many watching didn't think Test Of Faith was going to get to the wire in time, that wasn't what her driver was thinking.

Trained by Brett Pelling, who two races earlier saw his sophomore fillies finish 1-2 in the Fan Hanover final, Test Of Faith was notching her third win in five tries this season. This year she has just under \$200,000 earned with \$1.2 million on her card lifetime.

Bred by Fred Hertrich, the 4-year-old daughter of Art Major is owned by Melvin Segal, Kentuckiana Racing Stable and Eddie Gran. She is the fourth foal of the top race mare Cannae Cammie, who earned well over half a million dollars in her career.

As the gate sped away, there were several of the top pacers in North America looking for the front with Wheels On Fire successful to hit the opening panel in a quick :26. That lead didn't last as Linedrive Hanover blew passed him but he didn't keep that spot long either.

Last year's Gold Cup winner Allywag Hanover with Todd McCarthy at the lines took over before the :53.2 half. His reign wasn't long either as Jimmy Freight and Roy, winners of the 2019 edition of the race, came calling and had almost paced by Allywag at the 1:20.1 three-quarters.

Jimmy Freight was able to clear through the lane but he had another contender coming in Linedrive Hanover and the pair crossed the wire simultaneously as the timer tripped in 1:48 leading to a photo finish.

"After the wire James asked me, 'Would you take a dead heat?' I said I would because I don't want to get beat but I was pretty sure I won," said Roy following the winner's circle presentations. Allywag Hanover held for third with Warrawee Vital fourth.

This has been a renaissance year for Jimmy Freight, a 7-year-old son of Sportswriter who was retired to stud duty following the 2019 season. When that second career wasn't as successful as his connections had hoped, the horse returned to the track in late 2021 and has developed into a dominant performer in this division.

Tonight's effort was his 11th win in 18 trips this year and upped his 2022 bankroll to \$348,720 while lifetime he surpassed \$1.8 million. Trained by Richard Moreau, he is owned by Adriano Sorella of Guelph who noted how special it's been to have Jimmy return to the races.

As for the horse's future schedule this year Sorella said: "He has five or six races in the US, we have some decisions to make. Do we send him down there and leave him there? Do we go back and forth? He's been a little bit studly ever since he came back from stud duty. He's a little bit of a different horse on the trailer so we have to baby him a little bit."

Faraldo: reaching out to Jeff Gural on his Meadowlands quandary

1. Maybe telling drivers, some Hall of Famers, how to drive to suit a perception that is not reality to those whose expertise got them into the Hall in the first place is a policy that should be rethought. Drivers shouldn't be concerned about satisfying some preconceived notion about how a horse is to be driven. Owners seek out drivers who consistently use their best strategy more often than not, to win. That does not fit the niche of rigid rules. Owners have other options.

2. While the more information made available to the wagering public is very desirable, asking drivers what a driver's strategy is pre-race can possibly lock a driver into making a commitment that changes at the point when a driver looks over to his left when strategies often change. Down Under, where such a policy was utilized, some drivers were penalized for reporting one strategy pre-race and not adhering to it. Plus announcing a strategy gives other drivers some idea what other drivers' intentions are that does not make any sense. In addition, when a driver makes comments about a horse he isn't training his opinion can be deceiving.

3. Racing across the river in New York or racing in Pennsylvania is a person's right, so he/she can earn a better livelihood for his family by earning more money for an owner and his own interest. That choice should not result in that horseman being harassed and threatened that he/she will not be able to race at the Meadowlands in the Champion Meet. That is possibly a wrongheaded policy. While horsemen may not have to worry about the occupancy of the multiple buildings they may own, they have the right to take care of their business too, to best maximize their own income.

4. Other racing venues do not restrict or limit where drivers can or cannot go to earn a livelihood. Maybe racing participants are growing a bit weary of the limitations imposed upon them by management.

5. While amateur races are well supported at the Meadowlands, ordering drivers to leave their family or vacation spot to return and drive at the Meadowlands or risk being barred from being employed by an owner at the Championship Meet, while having them sit

out while five amateur races are contested presents to the professional the option to consider more attractive and efficient ways to maximize their opportunities to earn a livelihood at another venue. No?

6. It is often said that drawing the 8 hole on a half is death. On a big track, the same can be said about the outermost posts. There is a difference in that on a half, three horses don't get money. On the mile track, five horses don't get money. Leaving the gate with no chance of getting a tuck at all, means no money for anyone

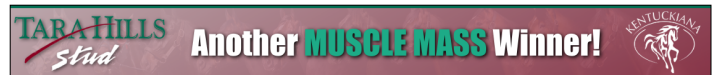
