A way too early look at the fastest 2-year-old pacers

As freshman pacers begin hitting the track, here's a look at the 10 fastest, so far.

It's only been less than two weeks since the new crop of 2-year-olds have hit the track in qualifying races, but there's been a frenzy of action during that time. Particularly in New Jersey at the Meadowlands Racetrack and at the Gaitway Farms and Magical Acres training facilities, the amount of early talent on display has been plentiful.

With 2-year-old stakes racing having kicked off at the Meadowlands Saturday (June 19, results unavailable before press time), the below list is expected to change rapidly. But based on the completion of baby races at the Meadowlands heading into Saturday, here is a breakdown of the top-10 fastest pacing freshmen.

JM's Finaltreasure 1:53.2 (Sweet Lou—Wordly Treasure)

One of two geldings on the list and one of three here trained by Ron Burke — who trains the top three — he paced the fastest baby race at Gaitway Farms on the morning of June 7. A relatively inexpensive yearling from the Lexington Selected Yearling sale at \$90,000 — considering he's a half-brother to Captaintreacherous — he capitalized on a pocket trip with Tim Tetrick to get up by a half-length. Though not on the list since he doesn't have a mark (at least at press time), an honorable mention must go to Treacherous Tom. Yet another Burke trainee,

he set the pace in that Gaitway qualifier with David Miller and was digging in gamely through the stretch before being collared late. JM's Finaltreasure will qualify again at Gaitway on Monday (June 21) and in the same race with the horse next up.

Wehadababyetzaboy 1:54.1 (Sweet Lou–Camille)

Another by Sweet Lou out of a champion mare, it looked like he had a lot more to offer in a wrapped-up win at Gaitway on June 14. He sat well off of a loose leading Holloway-trained Huntsville colt, but closed into the margin in the latter stages with ease to win going away with a last quarter of :27.2. He appeared to be doing it entirely on his own with no visible urging from Yannick Gingras; will get an even better read on him Monday (June 21) when he squares off against stablemate JM's Finaltreasure.

Just Divine 1:54.3 (Huntsville–Divine Caroline)

Also trained by Burke, she's one of four fast fillies currently on the list. She's also one of three Huntsvilles, too. That first-crop sire is standing in New York for a fee of \$6,000 and if these early performances are any indication, that price could soon be on its way up. In her lone qualifier thus far at Gaitway from June 7, she bested a field of three others with a last quarter blitz of :25.2 which was the fastest final split of any race that day. She sat last of four until the top of the stretch when Gingras angled her widest of all and got up in the final strides doing it on her

own. Out of an \$880,000 earning mare, she was a \$160,000 yearling buy from Lexington.

I Did It Myway 1:54.4 (Captaintreacherous–Flyme To The Moon)

One of four by Captaintreacherous and one of two Alagna trainees on the list, he qualified second time out at the Meadowlands to win easily by over four lengths in a time of 1:54.4 with a last quarter of :26.2 He rated the 5-2 morning line favorite heading into his Geers Stake division on Saturday at the Meadowlands (results unavailable before press time).

Stretch The Line 1:55 (Huntsville–Jessalilmixup)

Out of \$300,000 earner Jessalilmixup and a half-brother to \$120,000 earner Bestgirlfriendever, this one is a Goshen Yearling sale graduate of just \$16,000. He recently qualified for a fast win at Pocono to win by over 10 lengths with trainer Erv Miller in the bike. He debuts this week at Harrah's Philadelphia with Marcus Miller getting the call.

Atlas Hanover 1:55 (Captaintreacherous–Ameraway)

He was a \$170,000 Harrisburg buy and his dam is a sister to Western Fame. He's another that debuted Saturday (results unavailable before press time) in his division of a Geers Stake and I would have expected a top performance. In this most recent qualifier, Andrew McCarthy didn't even angle him off the cones until about mid-stretch but once he did the colt was absolutely airborne. He was credited with a :26.2 final quarter but he wasn't even asked to pace until around the final eighth.

Bermuda 1:55 (Captaintreacherous–Sweetest Emotion)

He first qualified to a 1:55 win on June 5 at the Meadowlands off a pocket trip, but then lost to Nancy Takter stablemate Lake Dora (Captaintreacherous–Bodacious Hanover) Saturday. The Takter trainees paced their miles in 1:54.1 and 1:54.3, respectively).

Market Based 1:55 (Sweet Lou–Economy Terror)

Out of 2-year-old champion mare Economy Terror, he's a half-brother to One Eight Hundred. Trained by Taker, as is his brother, this one was a hard-to-figure yearling purchase of just \$50,000. Having already qualified in 1:55 with a last quarter of :26.4, his career seems to have more early promise that was potentially first judged as a yearling.

Max Contract 1:55 (Huntsville–Big McDeal)

A \$200,000 yearling purchase, this filly kicked off her career by winning at Gaitway easily, kicking home in :26.4. Out of the sub-1:50 and over \$800,000 earning pacing mare Big McDeal, she looks as good as advertised in her early going.

Dragons Revenge 1:55.2 (Fear The Dragon–My Hare Lady)

By first crop sire Fear The Dragon standing in Ohio for \$6,000, this filly qualified nicely off a pocket trip to a 1:55.2 win for trainer Christi Noble. She was purchased from the Lexington Selected sale for only \$15,000.

Vernon Downs played host to the Empire Breeders Classic (EBC) for sophomore trotting colts and geldings as well as two divisions for 3-year-old trotting fillies on Friday (June 18). Andrew McCarthy won two of the three races.

McCarthy piloted **Ahundreddollarbill** (\$3.60) to an impressive victory in the \$205,500 EBC for trotting colts and geldings.

Ambassador Hanover (Ake Svanstedt) left from his outside post to grab the early lead. His stablemate Incommunicado (Yannick Gingras) took over the lead just before hitting the first quarter in :27. Incommunicado used a :29.4 second quarter to

hit the half in :56.4. Ahundreddollarbill made his move first-up from third going around the final turn. Incommunicado held a narrow lead as he hit three-quarters first in 1:26.

As they made the turn for home, Ahundreddollarbill turned on the after burners as they went down the stretch. Incommunicado just couldn't keep up. As they reached mid-stretch it was all Ahundreddollarbill as he won easily in 1:53.2. Ambassador Hanover came up to finish second best. Incommunicado had to settle for third.

Ahundreddollarbill is a 3-year-old gelding by Chapter Seven out of Swinging Royalty. He is trained by Tony Alagna for owners Crawford Farms Racing and James Crawford IV. The gelding is three-for-three in 2021. He now has five career wins.

Iteration (Brian Sears) was supreme in the \$102,500 first division of the EBC for trotting fillies.

Contested Hanover (Scott Zeron) took the lead and led to the first quarter in :27. Iteration (\$2.80) made her move popping out of the pocket and getting the lead at the top of the back stretch. She was first to the half in :56.4. She continued to control things by leading to three-quarters in 1:25.0. As they reached the stretch Contested Hanover and Moni For Lindy (Wally Hennessey) both went all out on the chase but Iteration had plenty in the tank and won in a lifetime best of 1:53.1. Contested Hanover ran a great race to finish second. Moni For Lindy got third money.

Windowa. The filly is owned by Courant Inc. and trained by Marcus Melander. She is two-for-two as a sophomore. She now owns seven career victories. She won the EBC just like her brother Gimpanzee did a couple years ago at Vernon.

Darlene Hanover (McCarthy) held off a late charge by Sweeping Rainbow (David Miller) to capture the \$102,500 second division of the EBC for trotting fillies.

Soukup Blue Chip (Andy Miller) jumped out to the early late. Sweeping Rainbow took command and hit the first quarter first in :28.2. Darlene Hanover (\$4.40) made her move down the backstretch going first-over from third and zoomed by to lead to the half in :58.2. She was first to three-quarters in 1:27.2.

As they reached the stretch, Sweeping Rainbow popped out of the pocket and the race was on. Sweeping Rainbow came charging as Darlene Hanover dug down deep and just held on to win in 1:54.3. Sweeping Rainbow settled for second best. Soukup Blue Chip finished third.

Darlene Hanover is a 3-year-old filly by Chapter Seven out of Danielle Hanover. She is owned by Yankeeland Partners and trained by Brett Bittle. It was her first win in 2021. She now has five career victories.

TALES FROM THE CURMUDGEON



with MURRAY BROWN

Trainer Gregg McNair on how Hanover, Ontario led him to a lifetime of excellence

"Were you born into the business?" this intrepid reporter asked of Gregg McNair. "Not exactly," was the response.

"My dad was into livestock. He occasionally bought a broodmare. That kind of began my interest in harness horses. Probably the biggest factor in my getting involved in the sport was where we lived. The little town of Hanover, Ontario was a great breeding ground of harness horsemen. I suppose the most prominent ones were Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Famer and multiple O'Brien-winning horseman Bud Fritz and his family. I started my career working for him. From there, I worked with Bill Lambertus, an excellent horseman, both as a driver and trainer, before setting out on my own.

"The first horse that I remember my dad owning was a nice trotter by the name of Speed Galore. He was just a nice solid

trotter that Bud Fritz trained for him.

"I took the first stable that I assembled to Windsor Raceway, where I stayed for around 10 years. Racing there was a great opportunity for me. It was a great place to race horses. Many top horsemen began, or furthered their careers there. Among them were John Campbell, Bob and Doug McIntosh, Greg Wright, Bill Gale and Ray Remmen.

"My stable at that time was almost totally composed of overnight horses and claimers. Windsor presented a great opportunity for me. The track raced in winter. People from my hometown area would send horses to me to hopefully raise some income at that time of year. My job was to classify them correctly and have them earn some needed purse money and/or get them claimed. It never much bothered me when a horse in my stable was claimed. One of the first important lessons I learned was that if you put one in a claimer, expect that it could be claimed. I think that it was especially the case with me, because I tried to be as realistic as I could possibly be when putting them in for a tag. I suppose that was something I inherited from my dad's livestock background.

"The turning point in my transition from being mostly a claiming horse trainer to one who specialized in training and developing young horses was with the best horse I had in my formative years, an excellent pacer by the name of Lusty Leader.

"He was in to race at Lexington. That was the first time I had been there. I was totally enchanted by the atmosphere. Of course, most of the racing involved young horses – some of which were superstars and others who were destined to become that. I ended up going to the sales and bought a couple of yearlings. I decided that was the direction in which I wanted to go."

Let's begin with Windsor. I understand that's where you began your long association with Keith Waples.

"When Keith would spend his winters training in Florida, his first stop on his way north would be at Windsor Raceway. I first became well acquainted with him there. He would stay there for a month or more and rented a room from me in a home that I had. What an honor that was. As most people know, Keith could be a man of few words. But like the man in those old E F Hutton commercials would say, 'When he spoke, you listened' and if you were paying attention, you learned.

"We became friends. I was stabled at Keith's and his son's Gordie's farm from 1993-2003. I've been honored to train horses for him for close to 15 years. I would say we've been fairly successful. He occasionally still rode behind some of the horses until fairly recently.

"One year Keith mentioned that I might want to try racing in Montreal. If I was interested, he would be willing to make a few phone calls to help me get started. He called Mike MacCormac who was head of racing at the time. I don't believe I've ever been treated better in all my years in the sport. As

for the racing end of it, I didn't do all that well, but it was a terrific experience. There were still a very good group of horsemen racing there at the time. Those that come to mind are Rick Zeron, Henri Filion, Jacques Hebert, Benoit Cote and Mario and Ben Baillargeon."

You have your own training center in South Florida. How did that come about?

"I suppose it was a combination of the cold, snowy winters in Ontario and the transition from being primarily a stable that concentrated on overnight racehorses to one that focused on young horses destined to hopefully become stakes horses. We've always maintained a group of older racehorses that we raced year long. We'd leave them up north to race and hopefully earn some money while we developed the younger stock down south.

"I had thought of training the youngsters down south for some time. It became a choice between going to an existing training center and paying rent or one that I owned myself and one at which I could call all the shots. I decided on the latter.

"The Henry family had their own training center in Okeechobee about 40 miles west of Fort Pierce which is about 50 miles north of Palm Beach. It's a fairly secluded area and is more countrified than some of the larger training centers in Florida. I bought 50 acres close by the Henrys' place, first intending to build a mile track. It turned out that to do so I'd have to have the house and stable inside the track. That didn't suit me, so I decided to go with what I feel is an ideally suited half-mile track. We've now been down there 10 years and it has worked out well."

You have a well-earned reputation of being very considerate of your owners. You treat them well and are completely above board with them.

"That's something that I'm pretty proud of. If I have a failing in that regard, it might be that I sometimes don't communicate well enough or that I can be difficult to get in touch with. But I try my best. I've had horses with Ian Fleming since 1983. My oldest owner, Ken Sommer, just passed away a year ago at the age of 98. I can't exactly recall when he first sent me horses to train, but it was some time ago. It might not

always be for unselfish reasons. I own at least a piece of most of the horses in my stable, so being perfectly honest with the owners means that I am being so with myself, as well."

You've assembled a great group of loyal owners through the years. What is it about lawyers for whom you train? Off the top of my head, you train for Jim Avritt, Richard Arnold and the Horner brothers Clay and Scott, all of them well known and successful attorneys.

"The two things that they all have in common is that they are all brilliant and they all care deeply about their horses. I've been fortunate enough to have varying degrees of success with them all.

"Jim Avritt is the one who has been with me the longest and I suppose he is the one with which we have had the most success. The best horse that I had for him was the world champion filly Precocious Beauty who earned more than \$800,000 and if that is possible, as great a race filly as she was, she might even be better as a broodmare. Her first colt being the world champion and 2020 Horse of the Year Tall Dark Stranger. Those who know Jim know how dedicated he is to his horses. He is very hands on in every phase of their development. Chances are almost certain that if you were to visit his beautiful boutique farm in Lebanon, Kentucky, it would be Jim himself who leads out the yearlings for you to look at. He knows everything about the dams and all the foals that they have produced. If, after you've bought one of his yearlings, you might think you are done with him, you would be mistaken. You will receive regular phone calls as to their progress and well wishes for their future endeavors.

"In addition to being a renowned attorney, Richard Arnold is also well known as being one of the foremost cattle breeders in America. He hasn't reached that status yet in the horse business, but he is a smart person and I wouldn't bet against that happening. I bought Bettor Sun from him at the 2019 Lexington sale for \$30,000. He called me and asked if I would let him in as a partner. I said, 'sure.' All we did thus far is win the 2020 edition of the Battle of Waterloo with him. I can't tell you much about him as a lawyer other than he is considered to be an outstanding one. But in terms of over-all knowledge on a vast variety of subjects, I've never met a person more interesting.

"The two Horner brothers, Clay and Scott, are somewhat different from each other. Scott is very hands on. In winter, he spends a lot of time with his horses. He rides behind the horses on a regular basis. He wants to know about the health of his horses. No detail is too small. I speak with Clay regularly, but in terms of what is being done with his horses, unless something is of great importance, he prefers to leave it all up to me."

How has this COVID year affected you?

"As with just about everybody else, it hasn't been good. But

I've been one of the lucky ones compared with others. There have been two big reasons for this. Firstly the makeup of my stable, most of the off days were in the winter and spring when the majority of our horses weren't racing anyway. Secondly, even when most of the folks in Canada were completely shut down, we were in a position where we could send our racing stock to the States and earn some money with them. It wasn't ideal or what we were used to, but we were a whole lot luckier than most of those racing up here."

This conversation wouldn't be close to complete unless we spoke about the apple of your eye, your son Doug. He is already close to, if not already, a superstar driver.

"Before we get to Dougie, I need to mention my wife Susie and my other son Scott and my daughter Amy. We are a close knit family and all of them, plus the dedicated and long-time staff of loyal employees, have all played a significant role in any of the success we have had.

"Now to Doug. If loving the sport and dedication to it were the sole credential of becoming a great driver, then Dougie would have been considered a sure thing. From an age where he first became aware of the horses, I couldn't, even if I had wanted to, keep him out of the stable or from going along with me to wherever I was racing. He was as the saying goes 'born in a feed bucket.' There were so many questions to ask and he wanted to know the answers to all of them. He always wanted to become a driver. He never stopped watching races, nor did he ever stop asking questions mostly from Bill Gale

and Jim McClure.

"Fortunately for Doug, they would always answer. He started out driving with his contemporary Scott Zeron at the small Ontario fairs. Because of their fathers, they likely got a better chance than do most youngsters starting out. But there have been other sons of famous horsemen who got the same chances and just were not good enough.

"Doug drove his first race at the Dundalk Fair at the age of 12. His horse might have been older than him.

"In 2008, his first year of driving competitively he won the Battle of Waterloo with our homebred Trail Boss. Since then he has won a host of big races.

"In 2017, he received an O'Brien Award as Canada's Driver of the Year. Among other achievements, he was the youngest driver to win 1,000 races and the youngest to drive the winners of over a million dollars in a single year."

Here's when this writer knew that Gregg McNair was a lot better than an average horseman. It was the fall of 2012. Hanover Shoe Farms had a consignment at the Lexington sales. Among the yearlings consigned was a Muscle Hill filly named Chivaree Hanover. The filly was from the second crop by her sire and the first foal from her well-bred dam. Then, as now, the Muscle Hills were an extra hot item. Yet, this filly brought only \$12,000 in a select session. To look at her, there was nothing wrong. She stood fine and had a pretty decent video. Except that she was a witch. If you wanted to, you could substitute the "W" in witch with a "B" and you wouldn't be wrong. She was downright nasty. If you gave her the chance, she would try to hurt you.

We told everybody who came to look at her that she could be dangerous — to be careful around her. Gregg was walking by the consignment and happened to see the filly being shown. She looked alright, which she was, except for her disposition. He was the 'lucky' buyer on her. Shortly after he signed for her, I saw Gregg and asked him if he knew about the filly's bad behavior. He did not. But he said for that price, he'd try her anyway.

In my mind's eye I could see her breaking jog carts and never getting broke.

Imagine my surprise when early in her 2-year-old season I saw her in to race. Not only race, but win stakes races. She took a record of 1.56.3 at 2 and lowered it to 1.54.4 at 3. She earned \$185,147 at 2 and 3 including several stakes.

When Chivaree Hanover was 2, I saw Gregg at Lexington. I asked him about the filly. He said that her disposition hadn't changed at all. She was still a nasty witch. The next morning I went to see her at Gregg's stable. Same old Chivaree, rear end ready to let go and ears pinned. I thought that if he could do as well with her as he did, when just about everybody else thought she couldn't even be broke to a jog cart, then he had to be a very special horseman.

Early days

by Alan Leavitt

My father came to this country in 1918, a penniless 18-year-old Jewish, Russian immigrant. An immigration official at Ellis Island, who clearly believed brevity was the American way, shortened Boris Levitonsky to Boris Levit. By the time I came along, his last name had regenerated to Leavitt.

My father was a linguist, already speaking six languages, and in three weeks he already had enough English to start charging for English lessons for refugees whose horns were even greener than his.

He settled in the Bronx, then a Jewish enclave, and New York was his home for the next 10 years. During that time, as he struggled upward, he learned to ride at the various riding stables that proliferated in those days. More importantly, every fall he would go to the National Horse Show at Madison Square Garden, each year being able to afford a slightly lower seat.

It was then, watching the beautiful, high stepping saddle horses, that they came to symbolize to him the realization of success. Like the green light on Daisy's pier that had such a special glow for Jay Gatsby, show horses held a deep fascination for my father, and he passed it on to me.

By the time I was 5 or 6, my parents were living in Hanover, PA and together running their first women's clothing store, Lobells. That later was amended to Lana Lobell, both in honor of my sister and to settle some complaints of plagiarism from a competitor who had a similar name, and had it first.

My father had, by then, acquired his first horse, a beautiful, dark chestnut pleasure mare named Scarlet. She was, however, also gaited, and I'm guessing her tail had been set. She was stabled with a local trainer, Johnny Green from Bowling Green, as he liked to introduce himself. He operated out of a stable located on an unpaved alley that was a block over from Hanover's main drag.

Johnny started showing Scarlet at the local, one day Sunday horse shows, that were everywhere in those days. He would then appear at our house the next day, Monday, at lunch time,

and he would report the results of the show the day before to my Dad.

Since I hadn't yet started school, I would be listening to his recitals. One of them stuck with me forever.

It went like this:

"Mr. Leavitt, I showed your mare yesterday at Red Lion, and she went good. That judge tied me third in the five gaited stake, but I got cheated bad. Everybody that saw it knew I should have been second. So I cornered that judge after the class, and I told him he cheated me out of second. And I told him, 'Judge, if I didn't have to show in front of you again next week in Carlisle, I'd tell you what a no good S.O.B. you are.'"

It was my introduction to the great world of diplomacy, and it has stayed with me ever since.

So now it was 10 years later, and my father had his own private trainer, Jim Boxwell, and three saddle horses. Jim showed in the open classes, and I rode in the ones for amateurs – pronounced am-at-er, and probably still is.

There was a three-day show every June in Phillipsburg, NJ, at the Lanark Riding Club. It was no big deal, but it came two weeks after the Devon show, which was a very big deal.

Jim, our three horses, and me arrived at the Lanark show grounds early, two days before the show would start. And to our astonishment, also already stabled there were the Dodge Stable horses. For some complicated reasons I never really

understood, Earl Teater, the Dodge stable trainer, had been persuaded to stay over after the Devon show, and there he was at the Lanark show grounds.

Needless to say, Teater had won both the three and five gaited stakes at Devon, which was par for his course in those days. His show string included Wing Commander, a liver chestnut stallion who was the reigning five-gaited champion of the world, Show Boat, the world's champion five-gaited mare, and Meadow Princess, the world's champion three-gaited mare. Wing Commander was then regarded as the greatest gaited horse of all time, and I think he still is.

For me, those horses and Earl Teater were directly descended from the Gods. I had seen Earl and Wing in the show ring a few times, most notably in 1947 when my parents took me, then 11, to the final night, stakes night, at Madison Square Garden.

That was the second, and last time, Wing Commander was ever beaten. Both times he lost to a mare named Easter Parade, who was ridden by Frank Bradshaw. The story goes that after the class at the Garden, Frank walked up to Earl, put out his hand, and said, "No hard feelings, I hope, Earl."

Teater shook his hand and answered, "No hard feelings, Frank, you got the ribbon and I got the champion."

Teater had quite a career before he signed on with Frances

Dodge, the automobile heiress from Detroit, whom he stayed with for the rest of his life. One of his earlier jobs had been with a woman from Scarsdale, NY, Mrs. Reed Albee. She was the adoptive mother of Edward Albee, and so for several years the three Teater boys grew up with the future playwright whose accomplishments included *Who's Afraid of Virginia Wolf*.

But back to the Lanark show, where, the morning after we shipped in, I found myself alone, standing at the edge of a track that ran around the perimeter of the show ring. There was a horse on the track, hooked to a jog cart, and I suddenly realized it was Earl Teater, driving Wing Commander.

They were flying, but as they came along side me, Earl Teater looked over, saw me, and said, "Hi."

Somehow I croaked "Hi" back. And then I realized that Wing Commander actually had a funny mouth, because right in front of me, he ran his nose out. Earl Teater's hands shot forward on the lines, and in a second Wing's head was back where it belonged. Then they were gone, and for the first time I understood that even though they were gods, they still walked on the same earth I did.

Father's Day siring feats

by Bob Heyden

Was Cam Fella better after his two-time Horse of the Year racing career? It appears so.

His first crop (1986 2-year-olds) yielded double-millionaire and Meadowlands Pace odds-on favorite Camtastic.

Cam Fella's last crop produced the richest female pacer ever Eternal Camnation (\$3.7 million plus).

The "Pacing Machine" also sired four straight Meadowlands Pace winners from 1991-1994 — a feat unequaled since (Precious Bunny HOY, Carlsbad Cam, Presidential Ball and another HOY Cams Card Shark).

Cam Fella is also the last sire to have had two different HOYs — 1991 and 1994 in Precious Bunny and Cams Card Shark, respectively.

No other sire has done this in over 30 years.

Pace runners-up make great sires

The Meadowlands Pace runner-up has sired by some big-money winners over the years.

They have out-earned the Pace winners 3-1.

In 1978, **Abercrombie** was named HOY. He was 22-for-33 and

was an iron horse who passed that trait along quite well. He had a big impact as a stallion.

In 1980, **Storm Damage** and **Tyler B** finished second and third, respectively, to Niatross in the pace, the sport's first million-dollar test. Both out-earned Niatross as a stallion. Storm Damage's Call For Rain won back-to-back Breeders Crowns and his son Redskin still holds the all-time 2-year-old single season earnings record at \$1.407 million from 1986.

In 1982, **No Nukes** was nipped on the wire in the Meadowlands Pace by Hilarion. No Nukes only went postward 19 times in his career, but his siring career was beyond outstanding — and right from the get-go, too. Can you say Jate Lobell? It is very unusual that two well-over \$100 million stallions emerged from the same crop, but No Nukes and Cam Fella did just that as foals of 1979.

In 1987, **Laag** was second to Frugal Gourmet and had a nice career a stud. As did third-place finisher Run The Table.

In 1988, **Camtastic** came from the initial Cam Fella crop and the fans loved him going in. It was Matts Scooter's year, however. Camtastic held his own after a strong career into his third million when he hung it up.

In 1991, **Artsplace** was second by a nose — just holding the place spot — with Precious Bunny taking the big prize in the first ever sub-1:50 Meadowlands Pace. Artsplace's siring career and impact are still quite evident today. His first crop had a Pace winner Dream Away and three years after he passed his son Sportswriter won the Metro and North America Cup and is in the top five ever among pacers in earnings per start.

In 1993, **Life Sign** fell a bit short of Presidential Ball and he too sired a Pace winner from his very first try — Day In A Life in 1998.

In 2000 **Astreos**, was next best to Gallo Blue Chip and went on to make waves in the sport for years to come.

In 2001, **Bettors Delight** was second to Real Desire, but is now the all-time leading sire in horse racing history with well over \$350 million worldwide, including his first HOY in 2020 Tall Dark Stranger.

In 2002, **McArdle** was a couple bucks shy of Mach Three — and

notable in that Pace was the absence of Art Major. Art Major would be the runaway leading earner that year. Both would go on to each sire a Horse of the Year.

In 2008, **Somebeachsomewhere**, in what many consider the best and most memorable race ever – his duel with Art Official off the :51.4 half and surviving to the wire in a world record 1:47. The late Beach has dominated right from the start and his name will live on for decades to come.

In 2010, **Rock N Roll Heaven** was the second Pace runner-up in three years to be named HOY. One More Laugh got him in the last step. Rock N Roll Heaven's sire career is more prominent Down Under where they wait on him longer and his older sons and daughters have stepped up.

In 2014, **Always B Miki** was second at 10-1 to He's Watching who posted the all-time fastest Pace win at 1:46.4. It's too early to tell which sire will end up earning more, but Always B Miki has about a \$600,000 advantage today.

Super sires Adios and Stars Pride

A big Father's Day mention to super sire Adios, who was the sire of eight Jug winners, including a mind-boggling five in a row from 1958-1962.

Meanwhile, Stars Pride, who as a \$2,750 yearling purchase, went on to a stellar career on the track and a legendary one later at stud. He sired 10 Kentucky Futurity winners and eight Hambletonian champs. He is the #1 sire of Triple Crown winners.

Hats off to Nickells clan

Hats off to Hall Of Famer Bruce Nickells – 93 on July 5. His daughter was oh-so-close to being the only female driver to race in the Hambletonian 20 years back with Lavester, who wound up fourth with Mike Lachance subbing. Brooke then was 2nd and 3rd in two Kentucky Futurity heats and final and that is the last time for the ladies in a Triple Crown event.

Other clans

David Miller's daughter Devan won in New Jersey.

Ron Pierce's dad Don won 50 or so races in his Meadowlands career.

Joe Ricco, Jr., George Brennan's dad, also won at the Meadowlands in its heyday.

Elmer Looney was something of a fixture on the Meadowlands backstretch in its first 15 years and daughter JoAnn and granddaughter Heather have been carrying the torch ever since. Susan won at age 16 with Won For All and that record is safe forever.

Frank Browne and Flo and Diane Browne all won in East Rutherford.

30 years ago

This year marks the 30th anniversary year of Father's Day in 1991 at the Meadowlands when 13-year-old Oregon beat his 7-year-old son Zealot in the same race.

Jennifer Brown – right-hand woman

Jennifer Williams grew up surrounded by horses and a family who was involved in harness racing, so it is no surprise that one day she too would make a name for herself in the sport.

"I was born in Bellefontaine, Ohio, and raised on a 40-acre farm owned by my grandfather and parents that included a racetrack and two speed barns which housed 24 horses.

"My granddad stood three studs: the most famous, if you call it that, was a horse named GT Skipper. We also owned numerous broodmares and at that time it was live cover so people would bring their mares over to breed.

"My two sisters (Amy Hollar and Stacy Beckley) and I had to clean stalls every morning before we showered and went to school. After school we helped with the farm chores and put the horses away, if needed. We also baled hay, fixed fences, worked the track and whatever else needed done.

"I rode my first a pony when I was 10 months old and granddad bought his first racehorse when I was around 5, so from a very, very young age I surrounded myself with horses.

"It was certainly a family affair, for my granddad, uncle, mom, and aunt all drove and trained racehorses on a small scale at Ohio's county fairs and some sire stakes.

"Our family has always been very close and after watching my parents work hard on the farm, they were instrumental in teaching us that hard work pays off.

"I met my husband, Brian Brown, at a fair when our families raced against each other. We got to know one another and one day when I was a teenager and we were at the Putnam Fair in Ottawa, Brian winked at me.

"He was 5 years older than me— I won't reveal my age, but you can say it was somewhat scandalous. I thought Brian was so handsome and to this day that's my nickname for him.

"In 1988, Brian and I got married. At that time I didn't want to

work at the barn so I got a job at a bank and also worked for a CPA for seven years.

"When my children started school I went to work full time in the barn with my husband. He is the boss and I respect him. Although I'm stubborn on certain things, he has the final word and no matter how much we disagree on something, in the end we're a team and want the same outcome.

"Throughout the years, I've been amazed and proud at how much we've accomplished and that we still remain honest and hard working.

"And by the way — all those rumors are true — Brian Brown is a good guy (and a great husband and father). He gives 100 percent of himself every day. No task is beneath him, and he doesn't have one selfish bone in his body.

"His only fault is that he takes everything straight to his heart, and if something bad happens, it weighs very heavy on him.

"For 26 years we've made it work because we love the horse business and each other. Yep, I hit the jackpot."

Brian Brown may be a great husband, but he is also one of the sport's top trainers and his record speaks for itself.

The Browns have conditioned many champion horses, such

as Prsntpretnperfect, Lost For Words, Blazin Britches, Color's A Virgin, Candy's A Virgin, Santa Fe Beach Boy, Special Forces, Beach Memories, Workin Ona Mystery, Fear The Dragon and Downbytheseaside.

The year 2017 was special for the Browns. They will always remember campaigning two superstars the took home harness racing's top honors. Fear The Dragon won the North America Cup, Adios and Max Hempt; and stablemate Downbytheseaside won the Rooney, Messenger, Progress Matron and the Monument Circle.

Having had so many good horses it would be hard to pick a favorite, but Jennifer says hers is Prsntpretnperfect.

"I bought her on my own at the Ohio Sale and she was a baby doll. I gave a piece to each of my kids. At 2 years old, Prsntpretnperfect won six of seven starts and only made a break in the final because we discovered she had a chip in her knee the day after. She won her last start at the Delaware Fair and at 3-years-old won 4 of 7, before we discovered another chip.

"Prsntpretnperfect was as game as they come and the family favorite. My daughter, Jessica, groomed her and knew every pimple on her body."

When talking about her daughter and son, Brown beams with joy.

"Jessica was a straight A student in high school then earned her degree from Ohio State University in animal science. She was my right hand in the barn when she was growing up. I worked her hard, but she didn't mind for she loved the horses.

"A few years ago, Jessica decided to go on her own and started a stable in Delaware while her husband Cameron McCown drives for her (and also at the Ohio tracks).

"On the other hand, our son, Beau Brown hated the barn when he was young because it was too much work. He earned a degree in computer science and worked for us awhile before going out on his own this year.

"He is currently stabled in Delaware, but is heading to Canada with his girlfriend, Teesha Symes, to try his luck at driving at the smaller Canadian tracks."

"I love having my son and son-in-law drive our horses. It makes me proud to watch them drive something I've bought and trained down. It makes it more personal – even if it's just a fair race. I never thought I'd be watching my own kids drive and it's been so much fun for Brian and I."

Currently, the Browns are training 55 horses – of which 38 are 2-year-olds. From April to November the couple trains at Delaware County Fairgrounds and from December to March they are stabled at Spring Garden Ranch in Deland, FL.

Decades after growing up on her family farm, Jennifer said she still enjoys going to the barn every day.

"Unless a grandkid has a doctor appointment or something

needs done at the house, you will find me at the stable. I do the bookkeeping, payroll, order supplies, make hotel reservations, stake horses and coordinate the rigs and who goes where.

"I've been a licensed clerk since the 1990s, was the NCOCC secretary after Mrs. Ruth Hornett retired, train and jog if needed, fill in for a groom, or give a hand when short.

"At Delaware I'm usually sitting in front of our barn, because that's where Brian Brown expects me to shout an order," Jennifer said, laughing.

As for whether the stable has any stars by Downbytheseaside or Fear The Dragon this year, Jennifer said, "I'm not sure about any superstars for we don't use that term, but the Downbytheseasides and Fear The Dragons are looking mighty promising.

"It's so exciting to be a part of their careers as stallions. I personally own two Downbytheseasides and one Always B Miki filly, so time will tell. But, if we never have another Seaside or Dragon, we were certainly blessed.

"To be successful takes a good team and we are lucky to have one. Our help is great and we have trusting, loyal owners who along with our horses have gotten us to this level."

French horses best in Finland

Two French trotters proved best when the \$195,000 Kymi GP was held in Kouvola, Finland on Saturday afternoon (June 19).

First choice Delia du Pommereux, driven by David Thomain, got her order to attack from her position in last 600 meters into the race. At the same moment, Anthony Barrier, driver of Ce Bello Romain (Jam Pridem) got the same thought, leaving a cover trip aiming for the position first over, at least for a while.

Ce Bello Romain landed outside of leader Next Direction after a kilometer and soon thereafter Delia du Pommereux replaced Ce Bello Romain in that position. The two French horses got some lengths in advantage in the last turn as leader Next Direction was disarmed and chasing Seismic Wave couldn't really challenge the ten battling horses in front over the stretch. Ce Bello Romain passed Delia du Pommereux mid-stretch, but the strong mare on the inside tried to fight her way back towards the victory and it was quite close when they hit the wire ([replay here](#)).

The 9-year-old gelding Ce Bello Romain held his neck ahead of Delia du Pommereux and driver Anthony Barrier seemed really excited after the prestigious win in a mile rate of 1:55.1 over 1.3 miles.

Unbelievable winner in Boden

Ten top trotters were gathered in the northern part of Sweden late on Saturday night when the \$192,000 Norrbottens Stora Pris was held over 1.3 miles.

The big drama in the race started right away as Vernissage Grif refused to trot behind the gate before the start. The Italian horse acted strangely, which has been the case with Vernissage Grif a few times earlier this season, and when he disappeared from the race, the path to victory seemed open for first choice Very Kronos and Erik Adielsson.

Very Kronos was stable when the car accelerated and from post 2, the 7-year-old Ready Cash son opened quickly for the lead. In front, Adielsson could keep the pace down with Moni Viking on the outside and the two front horses began to battle for real during the race's last half mile. At that point, the rest of the gang had problems connecting with the leaders and when Örjan Kihlström attacked from third over three wide at the back stretch with Who's Who, Wild Love did the same thing. That was not to the advantage for Who's Who (Maharajah), who had to seek even wider lane at the top of the stretch, at the same time as Very Kronos disconnected outside trotter Moni Viking. Very Kronos held his pace strongly and in 9 out of 10 races he would have been the winner, but an unbelievable finish from Who's Who was delivered and Kihlström was first at the wire.

It was an impressive 1:54.4 (mile rate) performance from Who's Who and high grades are given to runner up Very Kronos and bronze medalist Moni Viking.

In the first of two divisions for freshman pacing colts, **River Ness**, from the first crop of Huntsville, scored a one-and-three-quarter length win over Treacherous Tom (Captaintreacherous—Kate Is Well Said) in 1:53.3. Both colts are trained by Ron Burke.

The splits were: :28.2, :57.2 and 1:25.3.

River Ness, out of the mare Summertime Lea, was driven to victory in the \$30,650 event by David Miller for owners Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Brusceci LLC, J&T Silva-Purnel & Libby and Frank Baldachino. Bred by Steve Stewart, Oakwood Farms and Michael Robinson, River Ness was purchased for

\$45,000 at Standardbred Horse Sales Company's yearling auction in Timonium, MD.

Treacherous Tom is owned by Thomas and Scott Dillon and was bred by Fashion Farms LLC.

Two-year-old trotting colts were up next in a \$48,400 Tompkins-Geers test won by **Global Pandemic** (Cantab Hall—Nicole's Promise) in 1:56 for the trainer-driver team of Burke and Yannick Gingras.

The splits were: :29.1, :59.2 and 1:28.2.

Global Pandemic, owned by Burke Racing Stable LLC, Hatfield Stables and Weaver Brusceci LLC, defeated Theresnolimit S (Nuncio—What's Your Limit) by one-and-a-half lengths. Global Pandemic was bred by Concord Stud Farm LLC and sold for \$120,000 at Timonium.

In the second \$30,650 division for 2-year-old pacing colts, **I Did It Myway** (Captaintreacherous—Flyme To The Moon) scored a 1:52 victory with Todd McCarthy at the reins for trainer Tony Alagna.

The splits were: :29, :57.4 and 1:25.1.

I Did It Myway led gate-to-wire and defeated Pickup Man Hanover by three lengths for owners Country Club Acres Inc.,

In the last Tompkins-Geers race of the night, **Peyton Hanover** (Muscle Hill—Pennis From Above) won the \$44,500 test for 2-year-old trotting fillies in 1:55.2. Tim Tetrick drove the filly to victory for Marcus Melander. Peyton Hanover defeated Pink Gypsy (Father Patrick—Margarita Momma) by one-and-a-half lengths. American Beauty (Walner—All The Time) was third.

The splits were: :28.3, :57.3 and 1:26.3.

Peyton Hanover was bred by Hanover Shoe Farms and was purchased for \$400,000 by Jeffrey Snyder and Four Friends Racing at Timonium.

Racine Bell equals world record, takes Kissin In The Sand

In the \$50,000 Kissin In The Sand for fillies and mares pacers, **Racine Bell** (Jason Bartlett) equalled the 1:48.1 track and world record for a 4-year-old pacing mare defeating Rocknificent by one length with Lyons Sentinel a close third.

The splits were: :27, :55.1 and 1:21.4, with a closing quarter of :26.2.

The mile equalled the record set in 2007 by My Little Dragon.

Racine Bell is trained by David Dewhurst for owners Chris Lawton and Dale Lawton.

The victory put the daughter of So Surreal—Ty's Artist past \$400,000 in lifetime earnings. Racine Bell is now 8-1-2 in 12 starts in 2021, with earnings exceeding \$130,000.

Racine Bell was bred by Jim Winske and sold for \$9,000 at the Blooded Horse Sale in Ohio in 2018.

Graduate legs won by It's Academic, Beads and Ruthless Hanover

In the first of two \$50,000 third leg tests of the Graduate Series for 4-year-old open trotters, **It's Academic** (Gingras) held off Ready For Moni (Dexter Dunn) by a head in 1:51.3. Hypnotic Am (Brian Sears) was third.

The splits were: :27.3, :56.4 and 1:25, with a closing quarter of :26.3.

It's Academic is now perfect through three legs of the Graduate Series and sports a record of 6-1-2 in 11 starts in 2021 with earnings of \$643,688 lifetime for owner Brad Grant and trainer Burke.

The other Graduate split for trotters was won by **Beads** (David Miller) in 1:51 over a late-charging Hambletonian champion Ramona Hill (Andrew McCarthy). Get Legs (Andy Miller) was third.

The splits were: :27.1, :55.3 and 1:24, with a closing quarter of :27.

Beads, a son of Archangel out of Nepentha, is trained by Per Engblom for owners Buckstone Land Livestock. Beads was bred by Atlantic Trot Inc. and Steve Stewart and sold for \$60,000 at the 2018 Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

The win improved Beads to 2-1-0 in 4 seasonal starts and 9-4-1 in 27 career outings. The win improved Beads' bankroll to \$62,500 this year and \$334,213 lifetime.

The lone \$75,000 Graduate (fourth leg) for 4-year-old open pacers was won by **Ruthless Hanover** (Andrew McCarthy), who held off late charges by both Cattlewash (Miller) and Captain Barbossa (Dunn) in 1:47.2 in a field of 12.

The splits were: :27.1, :53.4 and 1:20.4, with a closing quarter of :26.3.

Ruthless Hanover, bred by Hanover Shoe Farms, is a gelded son of Somebeachsomewhere out of Rockaroundthetrack sold for \$57,000 to John Cancelliere at the 2018 Standardbred Horse Sales Company sale in Harrisburg. The pacer is trained by Tom Cancelliere.

The gelding improved to 3-1-0 in 4 starts in 2021 and 9-3-2 in 16 career starts. He's earned exactly \$100,000 this year and \$166,875 lifetime.

Test Of Faith wins 3yofp open

In the \$50,000 open for 3-year-old pacing fillies, **Test Of Faith** (David Miller) defeated Grace Hill by one-and-a-half lengths in 1:49.1 to remain perfect after two 2021 starts. The win pushed her over \$50,000 on the year and increased her career earnings to \$550,200.

The splits were: :27.1, :55.4 and 1:23.4, with a final quarter in :25.3.

Test Of Faith (Art Major—Cannae Cammie) is trained by Brett Pelling for owners Melvin Segal, Kentuckiana Racing Stable and Eddie Gran. Bred by Fred Hertrich III, Test Of Faith was sold for \$92,000 at the 2019 Standardbred Horse Sales Company yearling auction in Harrisburg, PA.

Behind the data lines (Part 2)

"Every company has big data in its future, and every company will eventually be in the data business." – Thomas H. Daven

He recapped, "Last week, you suggested that sellers of yearlings, who have the time and the inclination, could add supplemental data linked to the HIP sales pages for yearlings."

I nodded. "Yes. You always claim that data is gold. A deeper dive into pedigree and production could be both valuable and interesting for buyers. If information is coinage in this century, my two cents worth is that more data can help this sport."

He replied, "The keyword is data. A statement 'The brother to this yearling was one of the best I ever sat behind until his luck turned bad' is not data."

"Agreed. A statement like that is an opinion sprinkled with fairy dust. Last week, every example I gave you was a piece of data. The 2-year-old brother broke his right front coffin bone on June 2 in a training mile is documented. Regardless of how the information gets presented, all additional data must be verifiable or gets rejected.

"I was thinking about this type of information last night. I have only bought and sold a dozen yearlings. Still, I jotted down a list of data that was beyond the reach of the traditional yearling HIP page for this small sample group. These are data points, not fictional mumbo jumbo -

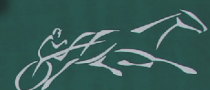
Sold at age two to owners from Norway. Successfully raced in Norway.

Involved in a horrific accident when the horse in front of this mare fell.

The second dam had two foals exported to Europe.

This mare was bred at age three during the pandemic shutdown when racing was not a certainty.

A foal from the second dam raced in Sweden.

A covid-related delay in OCD removal (the clinic shut down) prevented the 2020 yearling consignment to auction."

He nodded. "Okay, I get the concept. I agree that additional data should be in the marketplace. How do you see the implementation?"

"Start slowly. When the internet arrived on the scene, videos of yearlings began to appear. At first, a smattering of videos was just an option. But, that smattering quickly grew into a near necessity."

"You see this extra data following the same path as yearling videos?"

I shook my head. "Yes and no. Yearling videos have evolved into a necessity. If you do not have a video, buyers have suspicions and will probably not bid. This extra layer of information concerning a cataloged yearling will be optional."

I continued, "This information would be a case-by-case situation. Plenty of horses have very little additional relevant information. Their story is not complex. The production or lack of production does not require additional data. In addition, plenty of sellers will have neither the time nor inclination to create sub-categories of ADA. In my mind, smaller farms or individual breeders are more likely to follow their equine families and would be more likely to create ADA listings."

He said, "So, the lack of an informational link would not be a red flag."

"No. Besides, buyers spending huge amounts most likely have completed a deep dive into the family. How buyers value information is tricky, but the marketplace will determine if this is a product they want."

I continued, "Put yourself in the shoes of a seller of yearlings. If you are sending a yearling to a sale and you have some verifiable data that may make your yearling more attractive or interesting to the sellers, you want it out there."

He asked, "Who decides what would be relevant data for inclusion?"

"The seller would be responsible for harvesting the data and assembling the data in a digestible form. They pay the sales company for a hyperlink to the information. The sales companies are the middleman that lists a link and hosts the data. They disclaim any responsibility for the data."

"What are their costs for giving the customers this information?" he asked.

"Not sure. That would be a business decision. The links could be free for shoppers, or each click on a hyperlink with additional data could cost a small fee."

He pointed out, "The sales company would have a new income

stream without much effort."

"Here is the bottom line for customers. When buying a yearling, a product that will cost thousands of dollars, I am hungry for every scrap of information I can find. I will be clicking blue links like a maniac. The importance of the data is up to the customer to decide."

He said, "It seems like the question is: How much value would this product of additional data have?"

"I think a lot. Sure, the yearling marketplace is small, but additional knowledge has a place. The links could be enjoyable for nerds with wallets looking for yearlings. Any little nugget is a potential tipping point."

He seemed enthused and added a few ideas of his own, "The sales company could offer a one price option, to allow customers access to all hyperlinks of additional information. Plus, there would be data in the search footprints that could be of value to breeders and yearling sellers in the future."

I put a period on the subject and said, "Hey man, in this corner of the harness racing world, we have big animals with big price tags. So we might as well have big data."

Dunn's a natural, rolls a seven at Big M

Dexter Dunn was on fire Friday night (June 19) at The Meadowlands, guiding seven winners on the card to come within one of tying the all-time track record.

With the first race being a GSY Series event for amateur drivers, Dunn had work in all 13 races that remained. His first win of the night came in the second race with Always A Force (as the 7-2 third choice in the betting) before completing a natural hat trick by taking the third and fourth, respectively, with even-money choice May I Cruise West and 3-5 favorite Southwind Frost.

Did you think you were going to have a big night?

"I don't really think like that," said Dunn, the two-time defending United States Harness Writers Association Driver of the Year. "But I sort of thought I had some good chances later on the card."

The native New Zealander ran his win total to five after Caviart Lotus exploded home to take the sixth as the even-money choice before Think Of Galaxies went wire-to-wire as the 5-2 second choice, holding on by a nose in the seventh.

Dunn upped his victory total to a half-dozen in the 10th after taking the featured high-end conditioned trot with Chaptiama, who won from first-over as the second most popular wagering entity at odds of 2-1, then came right back in the next race to score win No. 7 from post 10 with 1-2 public choice Stonebridge Soul.

"Chaptiama was awesome," said Dunn. "A really nice horse to drive. He has a good attitude. He does what you want him to do. He couldn't have done it any easier.

"I knew I had seven winners [after Stonebridge Soul won], but only after Jessica [Ott of The Big M] told me."

The 31-year-old pilot was now just one winner away from tying the all-time Big M mark of eight winners on a card – a record shared by Mike Lachance and Brett Miller – but his big night would end there.

He had two good chances to possibly tie – and break – the record but went a tough parked-out trip with The Devils Own N (who finished fourth in the ninth at 4-5) and went off stride down the backstretch with Stirling Ensign (the 3-1 second choice) in the 14th and final.

"Stirling Ensign didn't feel good on the first turn," said Dunn.

Maybe so, but Dunn's fans certainly did on this night.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The last Meadowlands driver to record seven winners on a card – not surprisingly – was Dunn, who turned the trick on January 11th of last year. The Big M's leading driver, who won six races on a card earlier this year (on Feb. 13), is the current driver-colony leader with 94 victories in 2021.

A LITTLE MORE: Tim Tetrick drove three winners on the card, including the Marcus Melander-trained Hambletonian hopeful Dancinginthedark M, who toyed with his foes as the 1-5 favorite while upping his seasonal record to two wins in two starts. The son of Ready Express stopped the clock in a lifetime-best 1:52.1... All-source handle totaled \$2,846,303.

Fillies remain undefeated in ISS action at Harrah's Hoosier Park

After the 3-year-old pacing colts impressed in stakes action last week, the 3-year-old fillies would not be outdone as they highlighted Friday evening's (June 18) 13-race card at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. The program featured one \$96,000 division for the 3-year-old pacing fillies, and a pair of \$48,000 tests for both the 3-year-old trotting fillies and sophomore trotting colts.

Hot Mess Express extended her 2021 win streak to three as she delivered as the heavy 1-5 favorite in the \$96,000 Indiana Sires Stakes for 3-year-old pacing fillies. Driven by John DeLong for trainer Tony Alagna, Hot Mess Express was able to overcome post position nine to cruise to a four-length victory in 1:50.

DeLong sent Hot Mess Express away from the gate to grab the early lead through an opening panel in :26. Hot Mess Express would yield the lead to Somethingbeautiful and Trace Tetrick just before the half in a snappy :53.1. The quick pace continued but Hot Mess Express was content to sit the pocket until the top of the stretch. Utilizing a :28 closing kick, Hot Mess Express tipped out and cruised to the wire four lengths in front of Shelly Rockwell and James Yoder.

"I wasn't given any instructions on how to race her tonight, I just went off how she felt," DeLong said after the victory. "Obviously, she felt great. She was on cruise turning for home — she won very easy tonight."

Owned by Samuel Bowie, the daughter of Panther Hanover—My Heart Was True recorded her third victory of the season and equaled her lifetime best in the process. Hot Mess Express is now two for two in Indiana Sires Stakes this season as she pushed her seasonal bankroll to \$81,250.

Swift Swanda and Trace Tetrick would follow suit and deliver as the heavy betting favorite in their split of the \$48,000 Indiana Sires Stakes for 3-year-old trotting fillies. Sent off at odds of 1-9, Swift Swanda sat the pocket for much of the mile before angling out in the lane and trotting strong to the wire to win by three lengths in 1:54.

Trained by Erv Miller, Swift Swanda recorded her third victory of the season and second in stakes action. The daughter of Swan For All—Cheetah Hall has now amassed \$294,137 in lifetime purse earnings for owners Anthony Lombardi and The Kales Company LLC.

In the second division for the 3-year-old trotting fillies, it was **Treasure Gems K** who took advantage of a costly break by the post time favorite to score in 1:55.2. Driven by Sam Widger for trainer Norm Parker, Treasure Gems K was a two move winner to record her third victory of the season. The 1:55.2 victory equaled her lifetime best.

Owned by Norm Parker Stable LLC and Thomas L. Klosky, the daughter of Encore Encore—Treasure Bank has now won four of 19 lifetime starts. Treasure Gems K pushed her lifetime bankroll over the \$100,000 mark with the victory.

Driver Sam Widger scored a stakes double on the program as he

also steered **Brookview Bolt** to victory in the opening division of the stakes action for 3-year-old trotting colts and geldings. Uninvolved in the early stages of the race, Brookview Bolt staged a big rally late in the lane to get the victory in 1:54. It was the second win of the season for the Ron Burke trainee and the 1:54 clocking was a new lifetime best.

"He just has to mind his manners," Widger said after the win. "If he does that — if he behaves — he can race any way you want."

Owned in partnership by Burke Racing Stable, Knox Services, J&T Silva, Purnel & Libby and Weaver Brussemi, Brookview Bolt now sports a lifetime bankroll of \$207,550. The son of Swan For All—Witty's Winner has now won 6 of 16 lifetime outs.

Swingforthefences and Peter Wrenn were the final stakes winner on the evening after turning in a decisive 1:54.2 score in the final \$48,000 division for 3-year-old trotting colts and geldings. Driven by Peter Wrenn for trainer Melanie Wrenn, Swingforthefences made his game winning move down the backside and was an open length winner over Bluebird Maverick and Dale Hiteman.

Owned by David H. McDuffee and L&L Devisser LLC, the son of Swan For All—Sunday Yankee has recorded his third win of the season and second stakes victory. Swingforthefences has now accumulated \$193,056 in lifetime purse earnings,

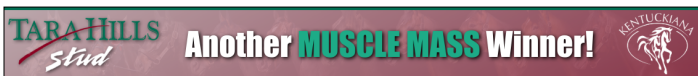

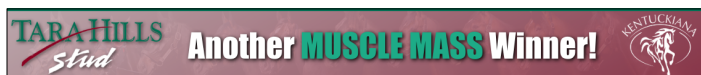
