Considering Palone keeps pushing into unknown territory with gob-smacking statistics **that are going to be awfully tough to match**, his numbers are worthy of some deeper analysis.

Just stop and try to think of anything anyone has done more than 20,000 times.

And that's just the victories. Palone has raced more than 77,000 times over his 40-year career, meaning his win percentage is north of 25 per cent while averaging about 500 wins a year.

That's a lot of left turns, through a lot of years, through a lot of weather and race conditions, sitting behind a lot of horses.

Palone not only holds the all-time harness racing wins record **by well over 3,000 victories** on Germany's Heinz Wewering, Palone has north of 9,000 more wins than the all-time leading jockey, Russell Baze, who retired in 2016 with 12,842 career triumphs.

To put it simply: When it comes to winning races, all the rest are currently 20,000 leagues under Palone.

Apart from matching the (alleged) number of women Wilt Chamberlain claims to have slept with, consider that in **just wins alone**, Palone has travelled:

- 80 per cent around the circumference of the earth (a complete trip is said to be about 24,850 miles)
- from the north to the south pole more than two times.
- from New York to Los Angeles more than seven times.
- the equivalent of swimming the English Channel about 1,000 times.
- up Mount Everest more than 3,600 times.
- the distance across Snake River Canyon about 80,000 times (Evel Knievel failed to do it once in a rocket ship).

Further, if each win was the equivalent of one day, Palone would have travelled nearly 55 years in time.

In short, it's a phenomenal distance and total and accomplishment.

One that deserves a standing ovation from a crowd of 20,000.

Six major milestones in Dave Palone's drive to 20,000 wins

On Saturday (June 25) at The Meadows, driver Dave Palone crossed the finish line first for the 20,000th time, becoming the first (and possibly the only) driver ever to accomplish that feat.

Harness Racing Update takes a look back at six of his record-setting wins and the impact they had on his career.

WIN #1 – MARCH 15, 1983, THE MEADOWS – CONDITION CLAIMER

An announced crowd of 2,920 came to The Meadows on a spring Tuesday evening not expecting to see any history being made, but in the next to last race of the evening, a 21-year-old Dave Palone scored his first career victory in a conditioned claimer (for a \$10,000 - \$17,000 tag) for a purse of \$2,100.

Palone tripped the timer in 2:04.2 with a 4-year-old Plucky Boy—Lisa Havens mare by the name of Reds Folly.

Palone rewarded his backers with a \$5.20 win and padded his wallet as he was also the owner of Reds Folly.

"It took me 24 drives to get that first one. It was a great thrill to get that monkey off my back," Palone said nearly three decades after that first win.

Long-time Meadows announcer and full-time Palone friend, Roger Huston was honest about his remembrance of Palone's first win.

"I honestly don't remember it," said Huston, laughing. "I can tell you that I probably announced 18,500 or so of Dave's wins."

WIN #6,562 - AUGUST 14, 1999, THE MEADOWS – ADIOS FINAL

For horsemen in western Pennsylvania, Delvin Miller was a legend and the ultimate goal is to win the Delvin Miller Adios Pace, The Meadows' signature event for 3-year-old colt pacers.

Prior to 1999, only two Meadows-based drivers had hoisted the statue of Miller's prized stallion — Dan Ross with Legacy Of Power in 1997 and Dick Stillings who steered Barberry Spur to victory in 1986.

In 2005, Dave Palone won his first Little Brown Jug after driving P-Forty-Seven to victory. In the winner's circle, the driver hugged trainer Kelly O'Donnell.

Palone was quoted in the winner's circle later that day that he would "trade a lot of those wins for this (one)."

The then 37-year-old driver had just survived a four-horse photo finish and won the \$303,500 Jugette Final with Maudlin Hanover.

What made this victory so special was the fact that Maudlin Hanover was conditioned and co-owned by his brother, Mike Palone. The younger brother co-owned the winner with fellow western Pennsylvanians, George Leon and the FLG Partnership.

Maudlin Hanover won her elimination in 1:53.1 and was made the 2-1 second choice to Beach Crystal (Richie Silverman) in the final, although the later was second in her elimination to Genuine Lady.

At the start of the second heat, Maudlin Hanover found herself fifth at the quarter and half-mile, despite having the coveted rail starting position.

Palone pulled Maudlin Hanover three-wide down the Delaware backstretch and stuck a nose in front around the final turn. The pair held off late rallies by Marfa Hanover (John Campbell) and Genuine Lady (Bill Fahy) and to capture the 29th Jugette in 1:53.

The 33rd edition of the 'Pace for the Orchids' featured the eventual Triple Crown winner, Blissfull Hall and driver Ron Pierce.

Blissfull Hall easily took the first elimination with a gate-to-wire victory in 1:53.1.

Palone and Washington Vc came off the pace and scored a 2 1/2 length upset in the third \$63,184 elimination. They rewarded their backers with a \$34 win payout.

The \$284,331 second heat starting positions were determined by an open draw. Blissfull Hall drew post seven and Washington Vc post three. Despite the poor starting spot, Blissfull Hall was bet down to 3-5 and Washington Vc was overlooked at 9-1.

Pierce gunned Blissfull Hall to the front at the start while Palone and Washington Vc lagged near the rear of the field. After being seventh at the half, Washington VC advanced three-wide going into the final turn and then drew off to win by 2 3/4 lengths in 1:52.3.

WIN #6,681- SEPTEMBER 22, 1999, DELAWARE, OHIO – JUGETTE FINAL

Dave Palone came to the Delaware County Fairgrounds on Jugette Day in 1999 with 6,679 career wins.

WIN #10,054-SEPTEMBER 22,2005,DELAWARE, OHIO - LITTLE BROWN JUG FINAL

Palone has Grand Circuit talent, but chooses to apply his trade close to his western Pennsylvania base and family. He currently ranks 16th on the all-time driver win list at the Delaware County Fair with 48 victories.

Before 2005, he had never visited the DCF winner's circle in the Little Brown Jug, but with three drives for trainer Kelly O'Donnell, Palone took two elimination wins (Up Front Tornado and P-Forty-Seven) and qualified all three for the \$307,277 final (Up Front Jerry – third place).

The third elimination was one of the most memorable elims in Jug history. Rocknroll Hanover and Brian Sears grabbed the early lead and Palone found a home behind Gryffindor and David Miller in third. When Gryffindor got into the back of Sears causing the field behind to jam up.

Palone astutely moved P-Forty-Seven off the rail and was forced to race nearly five-eighths of the mile on the outside.

Rocknroll Hanover was game, but P-Forty-Seven finally put his nose in front in the final yards.

Palone stayed with P-Forty-Seven in the second heat and drew the coveted rail position. If Palone was expecting an easier trip in the second heat, he was wrong.

Before 2005, he had never visited the DCF winner's circle in the Little Brown Jug, but with three drives for trainer Kelly O'Donnell, Palone took two elimination wins (Up Front Tornado and P-Forty-Seven) and qualified all three for the \$307,277 final (Up Front Jerry – third place).

Rocknroll Hanover was blasted off the starting gate wings and grabbed the early lead. Long-shot Roddy Bags Again (Luc Ouellette) left from post seven and tried to pass the leader, but created a moving roadblock for the rest of the field. Rocknroll Heaven's stablemate, Village Jolt (Ron Pierce) made a three-wide move down the backstretch and appeared to put enough

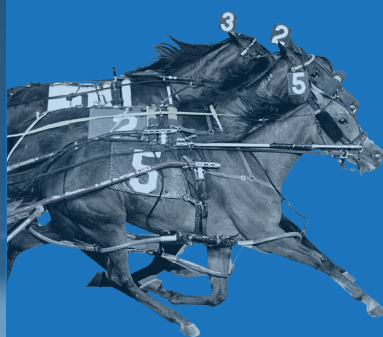

daylight between themselves and P-Forty-Seven, but Palone timed his move perfectly and scored a $\frac{3}{4}$ length win to capture his only Little Brown Jug.

WIN #15,181 - JULY 5, 2012, THE MEADOWS – CONDITIONED TROT

Palone came into the post-Independence Day card one win shy of tying Herve Filion's North American record of 15,180 wins.

Palone won the third race of the day and looked to have a live shot in the fifth, a non-winner of one event for two-year-old filly trotters, with Herculotte Hanover.

It looked like he would have to wait another 20 minutes or so for his next shot at the record, but Palone used the inside "Lightning Lane" to find daylight to rally for a 2:00.1 score.

Returning to the winner's circle for the 15,181st time, Palone saluted Filion by standing up in the sulky, not to show off, but to honor the man who used the same celebration in the Little Brown Jug and Prix de Ete, the Adios and the Little.

Filion, who was still an active driver at 72, was in attendance and was one of the first to greet the new record holder.

Herculotte Hanover was owned by Ed Mullinax, who co-owned Palone's Jug champ, P-Forty-Seven.

WIN #16,754 - NOVEMBER 14, 2014, THE MEADOWS – CONDITIONED PACE

Palone was enshrined into the Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 2010 and owned the North American wins record, and only one record remained - Heinz Wewering's world mark of 16,753 race wins.

Palone started the day four wins behind Wewering, but scored in the second, sixth, tenth and fourteenth to tie the German. The record-breaker came with a gate-to-wire victory in 1:57.3 with Missy Tap Tina in the 15th and final race on the card.

Following the race in a winner circle interview, Palone noted, "I am glad it's over; it was a lot of work these last 10... These have been the toughest 10 wins, the last 10."

The Meadows played a congratulatory video message from the German, who competed against Palone in the World Driving Championship in Sweden.

Caviart Farms' Judy Chaffee on her family's growing investment in standardbreds

Despite growing up in an immediate family without significant connections to the standardbred industry, Judy Chaffee, owner of Caviart Farms with her husband Buck, believes that it was always her destiny to fall in love with standardbred horses and racing. She said the emotional attachment to the horses and sport were innately passed from grandfather to granddaughter. Her grandfather, Lowell Chapman of Rockland, ME was full-time an engineer with the Maine Central Railroad. He also owned a small farm and trotters that he enjoyed sitting behind at the local trotting center.

“My mother, who also loved the horses, told me how my grandfather’s horses raced the Canadian-New England Circuit – that she remembered that his horse named Jollity was very successful,” said Judy. “She used to tell me that she wished that my grandfather, who had passed away, and I could have sat down to ‘talk horses’ because we both would have loved that.”

It was not until adulthood and meeting Buck that the standardbred world became a significant part of Judy’s life.

“When Buck brought me to Virginia to meet his parents, we arrived at their house to find a note pinned to the kitchen door. It said, ‘Come to Rosecroft.’ When we met there that evening and I saw the beauty and athleticism of the horses, it changed my life. Buck’s dad and mom, Clarence and Helen Chaffee, began buying some standardbreds and even a small Virginia farm. When we went to the backstretch of Rosecroft to see their horses, I loved the early mornings there, a cup of hot coffee in hand, watching and listening to the activity as the horses came and went to and from the track for jogging and training.”

It was still a handful of years before Buck and Judy became owners. In 1984, they went to the Harrisburg sale “just to watch,” said Judy. “Of course, the sale atmosphere, the thought of buying one of the beautiful horses was infectious – so when Buck asked if I would rather buy a house or a horse, I answered, ‘a horse.’”

Buck raised his hand with the winning bid on an Ohio-bred filly by Good To See You named Good Tal. Judy said that after buying her, they looked at each other and asked, “What do we do now?” A kind gentleman sitting behind us overheard, and told us to contact Joe Adamsky. He said that Joe was a good man and a good trainer who would do well by their filly.”

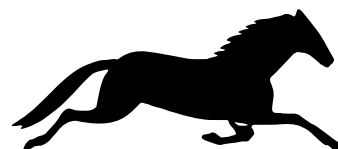

Joe did train her, and Good Tal went on to with the Home Talent Colt Stake Championship for her age and gait.

Today, about 40 years later, the Chaffees have climbed the ladder of horse ownership to the point where they not only have racehorses, but also breed horses on their own 235-acre farm in Paris, KY in the heart of the world's horse breeding industry. Down the road is famed Claiborne Farm and next door is Stone Farm owned by Arthur Hancock III, the breeder of such noted thoroughbreds as Risen Star, Fusaichi Pegasus and Sunday Silence.

The Chaffees also have a significant interest in the ownership of two of harness racing's most promising stallions, Tall Dark Stranger and Captain Crunch.

It was shortly after four of their 2-year-olds had won baby races at The Meadowlands that this scribe caught up with Judy Chaffee.

Q: You and Buck are two of the biggest fans and owners in our wonderful sport. Why are there not more like you?

"I'm not actually sure. A big factor is likely that not enough people know about our sport, or understand that we have the most incredible equine athletes that truly put on the greatest show on earth. It is an amazing experience to stand next to the track, hear the thunder of hooves as the horses pass by behind the starting gate – and then watch the strategy and the drama of the race unfold. I realize that there is considerable competition for the entertainment and gambling dollar, but what our sport offers seems completely unparalleled. At some time all racing fans and participants became captivated by the different aspects of harness racing. I believe there are others who could and would feel the same if only exposed to it.

"I wish that the casinos with racing would seem more receptive to promoting or even acknowledging our racing. Within many casinos it seems difficult to find signs pointing toward the racetrack, and there seem no windows to allow patrons to even see that racing takes place there. It is incumbent upon us to get help get the message out that ours is a terrific sport and a whole lot of fun."

Q: You and Buck have risen from small time owners to becoming among the most prominent owners in our sport. How did this come about?

"Obviously, because of our love of horses and the sport, along with an interest in building a successful business, we have continued to expand and increase our investments. This increase has not only been financial, but also goes to time invested, the number of people working with us in building and expanding our breeding operation including stallion shares, constructing new paddocks and our recent contracting for new fencing and a new barn. Where for years we bred and raced almost exclusively

pacers, we have ventured into adding some trotters as well. Perhaps the biggest and most critical change on the racing side has been joining in partnerships on yearlings. That allows greater opportunities for having a Grand Circuit type of horse, which is what we are always looking for. It also means that there are more eyes viewing each yearling for what we each like and see as possible flaws. Outside of an occasional partnership with trainers of our horses, our first real partnership with other 'owners' was with Captain Crunch. We really were lucky with our very first partnership. This past year, all but two of our yearling purchases were in partnerships. We purchased a filly named Kygo at the Lexington Selected Sale – a Captaintreacherous daughter of My Little Dragon – and regardless of her racing career she is destined to become a broodmare on our farm. We also purchased an American Ideal out of Darlin's Delight. We have thus far retained and raced most of the horses that we have bred and raised on our farm."

Q: How many horses does Caviart Farms now own?

"Currently, I believe we have just under 100 horses. There are 32 that are 2- and 3-year-olds – and of those 17 are owned in partnership. We also have 30 broodmares, nine yearlings, 17 sucklings, one retired horse with a forever home on the farm and have shares in 10 stallions including a significant number of shares in Tall Dark Stranger and Captain Crunch two horses that we campaigned."

Q: Who are your trainers?

"The majority of our horses are with Nancy Takter and Tony Alagna. We have been owners with both for several years. They are top class trainers. Additionally we have horses with Noel Daley, another terrific trainer who was actually the original trainer of Caviart Ally before he returned briefly to his native Australia. We also have horses with Ray Schnittker, Linda Toscano and Paul Kelley."

Q: How do you go about establishing who will be training which horses?

"Selecting yearlings from the Lexington and Harrisburg sale catalogs is my domain. I enjoy compiling a list of the most interesting yearlings in terms of pedigrees listed on the sale pages and from watching the accompanying videos. Buck and I eventually go over that list together, sometimes reducing it,. It definitely becomes shorter once we are able to preview the yearlings. Our trainers also offer their own suggestions either via a list or my suggesting particular horses that they have seen and liked. As for our homebreds, we try to divide them, at the same time taking into consideration which trainers may seem best suited for particular individuals."

“The year that we bought Tall Dark Stranger, Buck and I were actually only looking at fillies. Tall Dark Stranger was the only colt that I placed on the list. I never expected that we would buy him, but I was so taken by his breeding that I wanted to see him. When we did see him, I remember turning to Buck and asking, ‘Is there any such thing as a horse being too perfect?’ I loved him! Then when Nancy Takter called that afternoon to discuss fillies, while shuffling through my papers I mentioned that there was one colt that I absolutely loved. She asked his hip number. I told her, and if I recall correctly he was Hip number 60. Immediately she said, ‘How much of him do you want?’ Buck was not around at the time so that I said that we would take 25 per cent. The rest of the story is history.”

Q: What has been your greatest thrill in the sport?

“It is hard to name just one. Early on it was probably when our homebred filly Caviart Sydney won the 3-year-old Matron final over My Little Dragon. Or when Sydney as a 2-year-old won the Bluegrass Stake from the outside post 10, being in last place as the field made the final turn toward the finish line. She passed them all to win.

“More recently it was a thrill to watch Caviart Ally win the 2019 Breeders Crown over her arch rival Shartin N. It was always my dream for her to win the Breeders Crown. It meant a great deal to Buck and me when she was voted O’Brien Older Pacing Mare of the Year. I will say that probably the one race that was most exciting, one of the most exciting matches in the recent history of our sport was Ally nosing out Shartin N in the TVG! It was a race for the ages – a nail-biting duel all the way to the finish line. I still recall Ken Warkentin calling out a photo for the win in a bang

bang finish’ and then ‘1:48.3! What a race!’ I really think that the rivalry between those two great fillies was terrific for our sport.

“It was also amazing when Tall Dark Stranger won the 2020 Meadowlands Pace! In that race, just when it looked like he was going to be beaten, he did his classic ‘dig down deep,’ fought off his foes and came right back to win in 1:47.2!. He was the most gritty, gutsy horse with the determination to win every race. He retired as the only horse to ever win the Metro Pace and Breeders Crown at 2 and then the Meadowlands Pace and North America Cup at 3.

“Of course, it was amazing to see Stranger win the North America Cup the year after our Captain Crunch won it in a stakes record of 1:47.2. Stranger’s entire career was one big thrill. But we also had such a great time with Captain Crunch.”

Q: How about disappointments?

“One disappointment came last year. I believe that it was just one week after watching Caviart Camden set a world record 1:48.3 for 2-year-old pacing colts, besting Pebble Beach. He went to the Metro final – drew post 9 in a field of a dozen horses which included two trailers. Camden was three-wide for most of the race before finally fading. The race went according to the rules, but I believe that it is a great injustice to take such youngsters, just starting in their racing careers, and putting them in a field of 12 horses – worse yet with two trailers. I believe that this race continued to haunt Camden for the rest of his 2-year-old year.

The other disappointment was in the 2019 Breeders Crown. The judges ruled that Papi Rob Hanover, who was first across the finish line, had impeded Tall Dark Stranger, causing Stranger to lose momentum – and the win was awarded to Stranger. All of the colt’s connections then and now believe that was the correct call. Yannick Gingras, his driver, knew him best and said that he knew that Stranger was going to win. It was the colt’s way to let a competing horse be close, and then step up and beat him. While Stranger indeed captured the win, it broke our hearts that there was never the chance to actually prove which horse would have won minus that impediment. Regardless of the outcome, I personally wanted the best horse to win. I believe that it would have been Stranger. Forever and always there will be a disappointing 2P1 next to his name for that race.”

Q: Have you gone from training and racing horses to also breeding and raising them?

“The entire reason for buying our Kentucky breeding farm was so that Caviart Farms could breed as well as race horses. Buck

and I consider ourselves equally involved in both. However, our son Terry is most interested in the breeding side of the business. In fact, it was back in 2007 that the two of us traveled to Kentucky in search of a farm. Our necessary criteria was a decent amount of land, after hearing that the old timers believed that Kentucky's limestone rich soils promoted strong bones, we wanted the best soils. We did find and buy a farm with that great Maury soil. Once the farm was purchased, Terry took the helm of the operation, both as farm manager and COO. He is brilliant at caring for the horses and leading the day to day operation of the farm. He is the best. However, since Terry's main interest is in breeding and the farm will eventually pass on to him, we expect to transition to selling some of the farm-bred and raised horses at the yearling sales – aiming for 2023. Buck and I will continue to both breed and race, but once Terry completely takes over it is expected that all yearlings will be sold."

Q: To which stallions are you breeding your 30 broodmares this year?

"Caviart Farms is among the original owners of both Tall Dark Stranger and Captain Crunch. We have retained a significant ownership in both. This year we bred eight mares to each. Additionally, we have bred mares to Bar Hopping, Captain Corey, Downbytheseaside, Greenshoe, Huntsville, Lazarus, Stay Hungry, Sweet Lou and Tactical Landing."

Q: You and Buck have a large and growing family in which you take great pride.

"Absolutely. Our lives revolve around our seven children and 16 grandchildren. Our sons and daughters are all very successful and good people, and beyond that they are wonderful parents and great role models for our grandchildren. The grandkids are all great too. They are really growing up quickly. Terry is the only one of our children actually involved in our standardbred business, but all of the kids support our horses and can be seen at some of the bigger races cheering our horses on."

The exception that proves the rule

Joviality S seems to be the exception that proves the rule, in her case the rule that trotting fillies can't compete successfully against trotting colts.

I can't say a study of Joviality's pedigree provides an answer to her exceptional ability, but it does bring up some intriguing points.

First, Jo's pedigree is 75 per cent strictly American blood, and the 25 per cent of Swedish and French horses quickly runs to "Unknown." It's true that her dam, Pasithea Face, has a record of 1:50.4 with earnings of \$579,585. That, however, is her Phenotype, or the physical horse, and has nothing to do with her Genotype, or genetic profile, which includes her speed gene and her ability to pass it on.

The best example of her genetic range when it comes to producing fast offspring is to imagine it as a deck of playing cards, with a low card of Two and a high card of Ace.

Somewhere within that deck of genetic cards is each dam's speed gene, and the same for every sire. What Pasithea's speed gene card is, unfortunately, unknowable, at least to me, because I can't find any record of her production, other than Joviality S.

What her extended pedigree does show, however, is the extraordinary affect the late Charlie Keller had on the American Trotter. In Joviality's third generation, both on the Tail-Male and Tail-Mare sides, are two granddaughters of Yankee Duchess, Ketter's foundation trotting mare.

Yankee Duchess was a daughter of China L, an exquisitely bred mare of William Reynolds, who was a major player in our business for many years. Delvin Miller was his trainer, and two of his horses were Tar Heel and Solicitor.

Tar Heel went on to be the leading pacing sire of the day at the Hanover Shoe Farms, and Solicitor, later this kid's first pacing stallion, sired Overtrick. He's a footnote now, but in his day Overtrick set numerous new world records and won all the major

stakes, invariably against another great pacer, Meadow Skipper.

Yankee Windsong and Yankee Blondie are virtual sisters-in-blood maternally. It's hard, if not impossible, to think of two mares who have done more for our breed than these two.

Yankee Windsong is the dam of the Hambletonian winner Windsong's Legacy, who died after siring only two crops, but they included today's leading trotting sire Chapter Seven. Yankee Blondie is the dam of Muscle Hill, another Hambletonian winner, and today one of the world's best trotting sires.

As for the common belief that great racing performance in a mare foreshadows great products when she becomes a matron, it's instructive to look at what Yankee Windsong and Yankee Blondie did as race mares.

Yankee Windsong was the better of the two on the track. She sped to a qualifying record of 2:02.1f, while winning the princely sum of \$33,028. Yankee Blondie was the faster, at three trotting in 1:59.4, and winning all of \$8,434.

Yet, as broodmares, those two produced sons who have changed the course of the American trotting breed, and all for the better. Proving that pedigree is all important in evaluating the future potential of a filly or mare, and racing performance is irrelevant.

Now, a quick note about the new track here in Kentucky, Oak Grove. For starters, it's a lovely name. Beyond that, whether it's related to the extreme heat at the moment, which I hope it isn't, there's no dragging.

The horses post parade, take one score, and then off they go. While the handle isn't exactly being counted in millions, it's every bit as good as it would be if they made a joke out of "Zero minutes to post time."

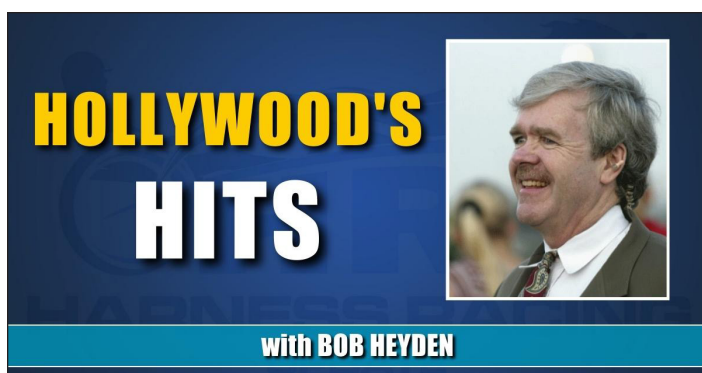
I know I'm a voice howling in the wilderness here, but it is foolish to think our business can continue to operate with a blatant lie built into our betting program.

We've lost Pompano because a casino company persuaded the Florida legislature to decouple their side of the equation from the track's side. How long can it be before other casino operators in other states decide to make the same argument to their legislatures?

And when they do, what better argument to hang their hats on than the obvious fact that we don't even respect the truth that our clocks tell us? Again, in the biggest betting race in the world, the Kentucky Derby, when the clock hits "Zero minutes to post time," the horses are being loaded into the starting gate.

Like the Pennsylvania Dutch of my youth would say; Too soon old, too late smart.

The problem that dares not speak its name

You may believe I am ridiculous, and you may be correct, but I struggle with anxiety as an owner of racehorses. The problem has plagued me for 15 years.

A 3-year-old colt where I have 50 per cent ownership makes his first start in three hours. This race should be an exciting event. This colt is homebred; therefore, four years of my life are at stake. I am not enjoying the day. Physically and mentally, I am a mess.

The hours drag on. Like a death row convict waiting for the jangling of keys, I watch the clock. I already have a slight tremble, and my pulse rate has increased. These feelings will only get worse as post-time nears. Ever since the draw, my sleep has been fitful. I lie in bed, running the upcoming race in my mind on an endless loop. You may think I exaggerate; these feelings are “part of the fun.” For me, these hyper emotions are not fun.

An unknown person once described their feeling of anxiety as follows: “We don’t have a train of thought. We have seven trains on four tracks that narrowly avoid each other when paths cross, and all the conductors are screaming in terror.”

Gambling is not the problem. I gamble on other horse races and other sports without a problem. However, when a horse I own heads to the starting car, it is an entirely different ballgame. A race as an owner involves a horse where I have invested more money than I should have, a horse I have thought about almost daily.

Many of us are afflicted with phobias and fears that people never see. My race anxiety is like stage fright. I have sweaty hands, a racing pulse, slight nausea, trembling, and an overwhelming desire to remove myself from the situation.

These emotions are somewhat inexplicable. I have teed off in front of huge galleries, played sports in front of filled gymnasiums, and spoken in front of large audiences. Those feelings are trivial compared to racing a horse that I own.

Economics might or might not be in play. My finances are such that I never sent a trotter or pacer to the starting gate where good performance and earning money did not matter. Would I feel as lousy facing post-time if I was a millionaire? Would the fear go away if the money was irrelevant? I don’t think so. But it is hard to say and a moot point.

After discussing this with a friend, she suggested that I have zero control over a racehorse and have no ways to channel my anxiety. She offers me a possible diagnosis but not a prescription for a cure.

I will take a break from writing these words to take a jog and see if that helps. Post time is approaching. My thoughts are scattered. If I don’t have a coronary, I will return in a few hours to report postrace.

* * *

The race is over, and my panic/anxiety attack is subsiding. It’s a relief that the race is in my rear-view mirror.

My trotter finished a disappointing seventh. The nice-looking young colt tried, and he was race timed in under 2:00, but he does not look like an answer to my fiscal prayers. I know the odds of getting a good horse are long, and disappointment is around every corner in this game. That is not the heart of the matter. Small purse or large purse, the uncomfortable pre-race nervousness lurks, waiting for the next race.

While jogging around the neighborhood, trying to work off my anxiety, a similar strange disorder in the horse racing arena crossed my mind. My pal and I have one broodmare, and we consign her yearlings to various sales. The awful feelings also afflict me before our yearling steps into the sales ring.

When auction time for our yearling approaches, the tension is so debilitating that I wobble out into the parking lot, start my car, turn to rock music on the radio, and occasionally imbibe something medicinal. I do not leave the car until I see my partner’s face and try to determine if he looks pleased or depressed. Once again, my lack of control in the bidding outcome may be a culprit.

Friends say, “Take a breath, relax,”

I don’t think many people calm down when asked to calm down. All this does is make me realize my unease is apparent, so in racing or at an auction, I prefer to suffer in solitude because the whole thing is embarrassing. I can’t help wondering how many others have these equine anxiety/panic disorders. How do they deal with them? Do they ever get over these feelings? Is this unhealthy?

If I can’t find a way to surf these prerace anxiety waves, I may need to get out of the ocean.

Joviality S, Justice impress in MGM Yonkers Trot

Heavily-favored **Joviality S** and **Justice** didn't disappoint in the pair of \$40,000 MGM Yonkers Trot eliminations for 3-year-olds on Friday night (June 24) at Yonkers Raceway, scoring gate-to-wire victories.

The lone filly in the MGM Yonkers Trot, Joviality S (Brian Sears) was in command through fractions of :28.1, :58.2, and 1:25.4 in the first elimination, successfully dealt with a wide first-over bid from Dover In Motion (Jordan Stratton) in the middle-half of the mile, and held serve over a closing Pour Mea Double (Dexter Dunn) to score by a length and a quarter in 1:54. Slay (Tim Tetrick) was up for third, and Brave By Design (Joe Bongiorno) was placed from fifth to fourth after Dover In Motion made a late break and was lapped-on at the wire.

"She was a little bit aggressive tonight," said Sears. "She finished within herself, and I was very happy with her. The track wasn't like the first night she raced here; it was a little cuppy inside."

Marcus Melander trains Joviality S, a daughter of Chapter Seven, for owner Courant Inc., whose AM Bloodstock Inc. was the breeder. Joviality S is four-for-four in the win column this year, she has 13 career victories from 16 appearances, and she has now earned \$1,065,366. She paid \$2.10 across-the-board as the 1-9 favorite and was atop a \$12.80 exacta and a \$63.00 trifecta.

Justice (Ake Svanstedt) trotted to the front from post four in the other elimination and was unchallenged through stations of :29.2, :58.2, and 1:26. Pocket-sitter Double Deceiver (David Miller) took a two-wide shot at Justice in the lane, but Justice had plenty left and scored by a length and a quarter in 1:54.1. Robertsin (George Brennan) followed in the three-hole and held third over Saverio Hanover (Dunn).

A **Chapter Seven** colt, Justice is trained by Svanstedt and also co-owned by him in partnership with Little E LLC., Torbjorn Swahn Inc., and Myfab Inc. Justice, bred by Diamond Creek Farm, has three triumphs in four starts in 2022, has tallied six times in eight lifetime starts, and pushed his bankroll to \$252,130. The 3-5 choice, Justice returned \$2.90 to win and keyed a \$4.30 exacta and an \$11.40 trifecta.

The open draw for next Friday night's (July 1) \$280,904 MGM Yonkers Trot final will occur on Monday.

Joviality S (Brian Sears) cruised to a 1:54 victory on Friday at Yonkers in her Yonker Trot elimination.

GULF SHORES, PLEASELETMEKNOW VICTORIOUS IN MGM GRAND MESSENGER ELIMS

Gulf Shores and **Pleaseletmeknow** will lead the field into next Friday night's (July 1) MGM Grand Messenger Stakes final for 3-year-old colt and gelding pacers after taking Friday's \$40,000 eliminations at Yonkers Raceway.

Driven by Yannick Gingras in the opening elimination, Gulf Shores left from post three and worked his way past Captain Cowboy (Dexter Dunn) to take over the lead before the :27.1 opening quarter. Gingras then hit the brakes in the second quarter and got to the half in just 57 seconds before having to pick up the tempo to 1:25 at three-quarters in order to deal with a bit of first-over pressure from Layton Hanover (Matt Kakaley).

Layton Hanover's bid ended on the final turn, and he dropped back, giving Captain Cowboy space to tip out in an attempt to chase down Gulf Shores. Captain Cowboy was able to gain, but it wasn't enough as Gulf Shores held on to prevail by a head in 1:52.4. Nautical Hanover (Todd McCarthy) sat on the cones in the three-hole and wound up third, and PJ Lou (Jason Bartlett) was able to close from last to fourth in the final quarter to secure a position in the final.

"I was very happy with him. Even with the margin, Yannick said he had plenty left," said winning trainer Brian Brown.

A Downbytheseaside colt bred by Joe Sbrocco, Joe McLead, and William Walters and owned by Country Club Acres Inc., Diamond Creek Racing, and Wingfield Brothers LLC., Gulf Shores has a record of 8-3-1 from 13 starts and has earned \$543,867. He paid \$3.60 to win as the 4-5 favorite and led an \$8.90 exacta and a \$19.60 trifecta.

In the other elimination, Pleaseletmeknow (Kakaley) made every call a winning one in a 1:52 performance. He blasted out from post four and made an uncontested lead after Market Based (Andy McCarthy) broke stride on the first turn. After stepping off fractions of 28.1, 57, and 1:24.2, Pleaseletmeknow remained clear in a 27.3 last quarter, tallying by 2 3/4 lengths over Hammering Hank (Dunn), who saved ground on the inside, angled out on the last turn, and out-kicked pocket-sitter Atlas Hanover (T. McCarthy) for second. Huntanover (Tyler Buter) was fourth.

Travis Alexander trains Pleaseletmeknow, an American Ideal gelding, for owner/breeder Fiddler's Creek Stables LLC. These are the same connections as last year's MGM Grand Messenger Stakes champion, American Courage. Pleaseletmeknow is now a seven-time winner from 12 trips behind the gate, he has now pocketed \$231,459, he was dispatched at 5-1, and he returned \$13.00. The exacta was worth \$37.00 and the trifecta kicked back \$143.00.

The open draw for the \$259,230 MGM Grand Messenger Stakes final will take place on Monday.

Gulf Shores (Yannick Gingras) won his MGM Grand Messenger elim on Friday at Yonkers in 1:52.4.

Ucandoit Blue Chip does it in New Jersey Sires Stakes at Big M

The New Jersey Sire Stakes season for 2-year-olds got underway Friday night (June 24) at The Meadowlands, and it looks like trainer Linda Toscano has a good filly on her hands, as her **Ucandoit Blue Chip** scored from just off the pace in 1:51.4 in one of three \$30,000 divisions for pacers.

"I don't know how [winning driver] Scott [Zeron] worked out the perfect trip," said Toscano. "He left enough with her to put her in play, and then she managed to get cover, just an incredible drive."

The only horse in the field in the field of 10 with a pari-mutuel start under her belt [a strong second, missing a neck in a 1:52.2 mile], Ucandoit Blue Chip was sent to the gate as the 1-9 favorite. Risky stuff for an inexperienced 2-year-old, but 'Ucandoit' proved up to the task.

"The way people look at it is, they knew she could go in [1]:52," said Toscano. "But I didn't think she'd be that short on the tote board. I don't like to over race my 2-year-olds. I like them to finish, but I did tell Scott you drive her how you want, just keep in mind she's a 2-year-old."

Ucandoit Blue Chip worked out a three-hole trip to the top of the stretch, followed a live tow from the pocket-sitting Devilish Dreams when that one swung to the outside for the drive, then tipped off cover before going on to 1¼-length score. Lisa Lane, who led from the half to the top of the stretch, settled for third.

Toscano is upbeat about what lies ahead for the NJSS program on the pace. "It's awesome," said the Hall of Fame trainer. "That's where the money that we got from the state appropriation is really doing its job. Lazarus right now is the hot sire, and Perfect Sting is the next big step."

A daughter of Keystone Velocity—Molly Can Do It, Ucandoit Blue Chip, who is owned by Bill Elliot, returned \$2.20 to win.

In the other division for fillies, **Fox Valley Adele** (Lazarus N-Put On A Display) scored in 1:53.1 for driver Marcus Miller and his dad, trainer Erv, as the 8-5 public choice, while in the lone dash for colts and geldings, **Lifes A Puzzle** (Lazarus N—L Dees Lioness) won in 1:50.4 as the 3-5 favorite for Tim Tetrick and Jim King Jr.

WARKENTIN AGAIN: Ken Warkentin registered his second consecutive victory on Night 7 of the Meadowlands Battle of the Masterminds handicapping contest, finishing with a mythical bankroll of \$368.

On-track patrons who select the winning handicapper on a given night are eligible for a nightly prize of a \$200 betting voucher and a \$50 gas card. The winner of that drawing is then eligible for a grand prize of \$10,000.

Warkentin, Dave Brower, Dave Little, Jessica Otten and Edison Hatter will go at it every night through August 5. The grand prize winner will be chosen on Hambletonian Day, August 6.

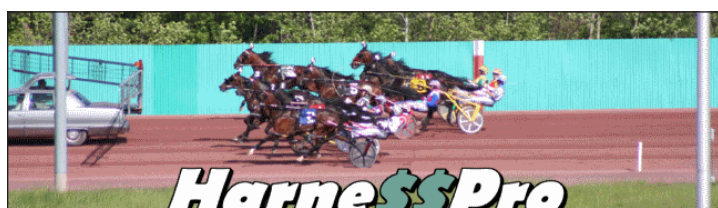

Gural: Faraldo "has no skin in the game"

I don't know why I bother to respond to Faraldo because like Trump he has a cult following that thinks I am the bad guy and he is the good guy.

He leaves out the fact that if I did not step up at the last moment there would be no Meadowlands and when times were bad before sports betting I lent the company \$18 million so that we could stay open and keep racing. I am still owed \$13 million and do not expect to see that money any time soon.

I am also the only track owner that I know of who has put a portion of the sports betting profit into the purse account. This year over \$4 million is going into the purse account from sports betting profits. I don't think there is anything wrong with telling the drivers to follow the rules which clearly state that if you give a hole to a competitor you need to pull rather than sit in. The fact that the Judges choose not to enforce this rule is not my concern. I grew up in an era where the drivers would never give a competitor a hole and the racing was far more exciting.

As far as asking drivers to post online their opinion of the horses they are driving is no different than when we interview a driver in the paddock or on a TV show and ask him how he thinks the horses he is driving are going to race. Most of our simulcast customers are watching the races and not listening to sound so having this information prior to the start of the card could only help. We agree that anyone driving regularly at the Meadowlands should be able to take time off over the winter if they so choose to recharge their batteries but I don't think it is unreasonable to come back by April 1.

We expect to lose \$5 million on racing this year and I think it is not unfair to ask our drivers to help the handle and be back on April 1. Joe receives \$50 million at Yonkers in purse subsidies and if we are lucky we receive about \$6 million so obviously his purses are better and it is easier to make money

racing at tracks that have slot subsidies but my guess is most horse owners would much rather race at the Meadowlands and hopefully actually watch in person and eat in Trotters as opposed to having a hot dog at Yonkers standing outside.

As far as the amateur races are concerned, the sad fact is that on a typical Friday we handle more on two amateur races than Yonkers does on the entire card. I don't expect my comments to change anyone's opinion, but it is hard to be constantly criticized by someone who unlike myself has no skin in the game.
