Meadowlands Pace draws 12, requires one elimination

Chief Mate and Allywag Hanover opted to take a bye to the \$631,500 final slated for July 18.

With a limited number of 12 horses having dropped into the entry box, there will only be one Meadowlands Pace elimination necessary on this Saturday (July 11) night's program at the Big M. Post time is 7:15 p.m.

Two horses – Chief Mate and Allywag Hanover – took byes and will automatically go in the July 18 big-money final for 3-year-old open pacers.

Conditions call for those with the highest earnings this season getting the option to skip the elim. Trainer Mark Harder wanted Major Betts to race, so he's in this Saturday. As a result, Chief Mate and Allywag Hanover, who were next in line in 2020 earnings, took a free pass to the final.

The elimination has a field of 10, with the first eight in official order of finish advancing to the \$631,650 final. The elimination winner will get a major perk: That horse will draw a post position from one through six.

Tall Dark Stranger has drawn post three in the elim. The Nancy Takter trainee's only start this year resulted in a national season's-best equaling mile of 1:47.4. The Brett Pelling-schooled Papi Rob Hanover, second in his 2020 debut a week ago after a tough trip from post 10, once again was

luckless at the pill drop, having drawn the 10 hole for a second straight start.

The field for Saturday night's Meadowlands Pace elimination in post-position order, with horse (and driver): Major Betts (Dexter Dunn), Captain Barbossa (Andrew McCarthy), Tall Dark Stranger (Yannick Gingras), Manticore (Jordan Stratton), Captain Kirk (Dunn), Roll With Jr (Tim Tetrick), Mocha On The Rocks (Scott Zeron), Catch The Fire (Mike Wilder), Capt Midnight (McCarthy), Papi Rob Hanover (David Miller).

Also on Saturday's program are a pair of \$250,000 Graduate finals. The open events for 4-year-olds – one for pacers and one on the trot – both have full fields of 10.

The trot has double Breeders Crown and New York Sire Stakes champion Gimpanzee as the one with the target on his back. He's been ultra-impressive in winning both of his starts this year – each of which were Graduate preliminaries – by scoring once on the front end and once from well off the pace.

The field for the Graduate Final for trotters in post-position order, with horse (and driver): Chin Chin Hall (Dunn), Kings County (D. Miller), Gimpanzee (Brian Sears), Winnerup (Trond Smedshammer), Explosivebreakaway (Tetrick), Southwind Avenger (McCarthy), Goes Down Smooth (No Driver), Pure Chance (No Driver), Grand Swan (Tetrick), Reign Of Honor (D. Miller).

Bettor's Wish was the top money-earning horse in harness racing a year ago with over \$1.6 million in the bank, and despite drawing post 10, will likely be the post-time favorite in the Graduate for pacers off his 1:48.2 off-the-pace win a week ago at the Meadowlands in the series' final leg.

Mike Watson has deep conviction to horses and family

It didn't take Mike Watson long to realize that horse stalls, not office walls, was his true calling.

Soon after he completed high school, the opportunity to work alongside his grandfather, Curt Watson, and father, Curt Sr., presented itself to the Michigan teenager.

"I remember that my father and grandfather, who worked for a company called Centri-Spray Corp, wanted me to come work there with them," said Watson. "I worked there for about six months and then one day I said, 'No way. I'm not doing this.' And I was out the door."

It wasn't about what he didn't want to do for a living. Instead, it was about the one thing which he felt he had the strongest connection.

Watson often thought about what he felt was his career calling during that short time at Centri-Spray Corp, and even more so on the day he tendered his resignation.

"We've had horses since we were little kids. My grandfather had quarter horses and thoroughbreds. The standardbreds, my uncle – my mother's brother – ended up buying my brother and I one at a sale in Michigan. I was probably 11 and my brother [also, Curt] was 13 or 14. That's how we started with the first one. His name was Mischief Mark."

A bay son of Boxer Hanover, the pacer, born in 1967, delivered the brothers their first glimpse of life at the racetrack.

"Two bowed tendons, but we had a good time with him," recalled Mike. "I have to say that I've had a pretty good time in this business. I can't complain."

Looking at his stat sheet tells you why he wouldn't.

Starting his training career in 1982, the affable horseman has racked up over 2,500 wins since that time.

Based in Wind Gap, PA, a town that's found about a

one-and-a-half hour drive northeast of Philadelphia, Watson continues to fare well in the Keystone State.

Although the COVID-19 pandemic has wreaked havoc on his current campaign, he hasn't let the tough times diffuse his enthusiasm for the sport.

"At the time that the pandemic happened, I had 25 horses. So, I had to make a decision on what to do with them all when racing shut down. I took about half of them and turned them out for a couple of weeks, brought them back in, then turned the others out for a couple of weeks. I had to make the decision as to who to leave out for a while and who to keep going with. That's pretty much how I did it. Now, they're all in. Most of them are racing, but I still need to qualify 10 of them."

Even during the temporary pause to live racing in Pennsylvania and across North America, Watson, who has recorded nine seasons of 100-plus wins, remained committed to his craft, and to an industry that he still has a great fondness for.

What keeps him coming back every day?

"I love it. I love the horses. I love the freedom. Each morning you walk into the barn and see the horses, see all of their different personalities... it's a great feeling. I really

enjoy being around the horses and spending time with them. And it never gets old for me.”

Watson has been able to share his affinity for standardbreds with his two daughters, Hillary, and Kailee.

The siblings have worked alongside their father for several years.

“Hillary [28] and Kailee [26] ran the barn,” said Watson, who won a career-best 134 races in 2001, coming close to matching the number when he tallied 128 victories in 2014. “For the last 15 years, they’ve been in the barn. Actually, they’ve been around the barn since they were babies. Now, they have children of their own. Hillary has a son, Lane, and Kailee has a daughter, Nora. My daughters, they’ve always enjoyed being around the horses. It’s nice to see their children here now.”

Family, more specifically, making time for Kathy, his wife of 29 years, and for young children, was a challenge for Watson early on his career.

It’s far less of an issue these days.

“This is a tough business to be in. I always tried to be around for them because I’ve seen what it can be like for kids who have parents in horse racing. This sport takes up a lot of time and there’s always something that has to be done. You can tell your wife you’ll be home in 20 minutes and three hours later, you’re still not there. It was a little tough. There were definitely some tough times when the kids were small, but we worked through it. For me, racing should be a family affair. My kids, they love these horses. So do I. Hopefully, the grandchildren do too.”

Beyond hard work, skill and the occasional good fortune, Watson points to one particular reason for his enduring success.

“You have to have good owners, owners that will buy good horses. They’ve come and gone over the years, but I’ve been very fortunate to have had such great owners in my nearly 40 years in racing. My ex-brother-in-law, Cliff Grundy, I’ve had horses with him for 30-plus years. He buys horses left and right. It’s worked out for well for me because he likes to claim horses.”

While Watson shies away from talking about his own accomplishments, the numbers, impressive ones, speak for themselves.

After a 74-win campaign in 2019, the veteran trainer has managed to hold his own this year as he works to get his stable of 25 horses into full gear.

With plenty to look forward to, don’t expect Watson to contemplate retirement any time soon.

Not when he’s still at the top of his game.

“I like it here in Pennsylvania. It’s tough racing, but we get by pretty well. I doubt if [retirement is] on the radar. Everybody says that. Who in this business ever gets out of it? Some do, but not too many. I’ve seen good times and bad times, but mostly, it’s been good times. I guess you could say I’m a die-hard.”

USTA announces creation of Standardbred Racing Investigative Fund

As part of the initiative that commenced with Hanover Shoe Farms' executive vice-president Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky's announcement in April of a \$250,000 matching fund grant to promote integrity in harness racing, on Monday (July 6), U.S. Trotting Association president Russell Williams announced the establishment of the Standardbred Racing Investigative Fund.

The SRIF will exist as a division of the USTA but with independent, third-party oversight.

"After announcing the \$250,000 challenge grant, we heard from several industry stakeholders who were concerned about industry participants having the ability to exert influence on or make decisions regarding investigations into possible regulatory or criminal abuses," said Williams, who is president and CEO of Hanover Shoe Farms.

"These concerns are valid, so we have worked diligently with a leading Pennsylvania law firm to design a structure that would remove funding and investigative decision-making from the USTA and allow for total confidentiality. This difficult task has taken time, but it is almost complete."

The plan for the SRIF will be presented at an upcoming USTA Board of Directors Executive Committee meeting to be held within the next few weeks in order to gain Board approval.

If approved, complete details including who will serve on the SRIF Oversight Board, the way that money from donations will be allocated, how investigations will be conducted, and details of the plan for cooperative efforts with state racing commissions and local, state and federal authorities will be announced.

Insta Glam equals stake record Monday in PASS at The Meadows

Insta Glam made her career debut an impressive one, matching the stakes record 1:55 in Monday's (July 6) \$210,221 Pennsylvania Sires Stake at The Meadows. The event for freshman filly trotters, known as the Meadow Gladys, was contested over three divisions, with **Pub Crawl** and **Lady Chaos** taking the other splits.

A homebred daughter of Father Patrick—Hollywood Hill, Insta Glam was away third before Yannick Gingras quarter-poled her to the point. She had the field at her mercy at the top of the lane and drew off to defeat 60-1 long shot You Ato Dream by 4-1/4 lengths, with May Karp third. Her time equaled the stake mark established by Vivacious Allie in 2017.

"She's like an old pro," Gingras said. "She's so mature, does everything you need her to do. She's got it figured out already. One lifetime start and she's got it figured out."

Nancy Takter, who trains Insta Glam for Goran Falk and Christina Takter, said the youngster has a full card of stakes engagements, including the Jim Doherty Trot July 31 at the Meadowlands.

Pub Crawl had the sort of demanding journey few 2-year-olds like. Used from post 8 for early position, first up, pushed wide into the final turn. Yet with Andy Miller at the helm, the daughter of Bar Hopping—Myth made it all work, prevailing in 1:55.4, a head better than Lexa Hanover. Mazzarati completed the ticket.

"We ended up three deep in the last turn — didn't really want to be there," Miller said. "But she kept going, kept digging all the way to the wire. It was a pretty big mile for this early. She'll stay in sires stakes for now; hopefully somewhere down the line we can do a little Grand Circuit racing."

Julie Miller conditions Pub Crawl for Andy Miller Stable, Louis Willinger, Kapildeo Singh and Phillip Helmuth. Lady Chaos endured some early adversity of her own in her career bow, parked three wide to the quarter from post 8.

"I was worried because I like this filly, and I wanted to see her get started on the right note," said trainer Linda Toscano of her \$125,000 yearling acquisition. "But she put in a great effort. She had a horse coming at her down the stretch and she still finished ahead."

The daughter of Cantab Hall—Strong Legacy cleared past the quarter for David Miller and held off the Lightning Lane

challenge of Kayla's Playmate to down her by a head in 1:57, with Flawless Country third.

Richard Gutnick, Thomas Pontone, Joseph Lozito, Jr. and Enviro Stables campaign Lady Chaos.

In Monday's companion feature, the \$80,000 PA Stallion Series for freshman trotting fillies, **Love Muffin** zipped to the lead from post 8, picked up key cover and brushed through the Lightning Lane to triumph in 1:57, erasing the stake record Lady Athena set in 2015. Also taking splits were **Midpoint**, **Alpine** and **Bless Your Heart**. Trainer Per Engblom enjoyed a stake double with Midpoint and Alpine.

Trainer David Wiest indicated he told winning driver Jim Pantaleano that Love Muffin is an aggressive filly who would leave well for him.

"She's aggressive, but she's easy to handle out of the gate," Wiest said. "I told Jim she's a nice, sensible filly to drive. At this point, we plan on keeping her in the stallion series. She has some other stakes later in the year."

With her Lightning Lane charge, the homebred daughter of Andover Hall, owned by Ed Kimmel and Don Wiest, defeated Myreanna by 3/4 lengths. Cheesy Hanover earned show.

Live racing at The Meadows continues Tuesday when the card features a \$5,000 total-pool guarantee for the Early Pick 4 (race 3). First post is 12:45 PM.

American Courage and Carrythetorchman win MGM Springfield Stakes elims at Yonkers

Yonkers Raceway featured two elimination races Monday night (July 6) for the first 2-year-old stakes of the season, the MGM Springfield Stakes, on Monday night.

In the first elimination, **American Courage** brushed to the lead approaching the half and was an easy seven and one-quarter length winner in 1:55.2 over Town Gossip with Crystal Beach third and Major Makover fourth.

The 1-5 favorite, American Courage paid \$2.70 to win. The son of American Ideal—Nota Fool Bluechip was driven to victory by Matt Kakaley for trainer Travis Alexander and the Fiddler's Creek Stables of West Bloomfield, MI.

In the second elimination, **Carrythetorchman** took control of the race from the start and led wire to wire to a 1:55.4 victory. Coalition Hanover was a length a half back in second with Victory Move third and Not Today fourth.

Carrythetorchman, a son of American Ideal—Kattimon, also paid \$2.70 to win and was driven to victory by Scott Zeron

for trainer Erv Miller and owners Ronald Michelin of Northbrook, Illinois and War Horse Stables of Malvern, Pennsylvania.

Sophomore pacing colts set and re-set Canadian speed mark

A fluke accident cost **Beaumont Hanover** shot at Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) glory last season, but trainer Jack Darling was always confident the pacing colt was Gold Series calibre and that faith was rewarded at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday (July 4).

Starting from Post 7, driver Jody Jamieson had Beaumont Hanover on the move early and the fan favorite took command from Denali Seelster as the colts reached the :26.4 quarter. From there Beaumont Hanover cruised to a :54.4 half, and when Mayhem Hanover mounted a challenge heading for the 1:22.2 three-quarters Jamieson shifted the strapping youngster into a bigger gear. Powering down the stretch Beaumont Hanover opened up a three and three-quarter length margin on his peers and stopped the teletimer in a Canadian season's best 1:49.1. Examiner Hanover finished second and Denali Seelster was third.

"He's just a really nice horse. It's kind of an honor to have a horse like that, he just seems perfect in every way," said owner/trainer Jack Darling. "He was always our best colt. We had high hopes for him. We were pretty sure he was going to be a good Gold colt last year, but he has come back strong this year. You're always hoping for it, but you never expect them to be this good."

The son of Sportswriter trained down in impressive fashion and had one qualifier under his belt last June when he kicked the fence in the paddock and suffered a bone bruise that would take two months to heal. Beaumont Hanover returned to action in September and won four of five starts, including two legs and the final of the Harvest Series, before Darling opted to wrap up his freshman campaign.

This season, Beaumont Hanover opened the season with a five-length win in 1:49.4 and then finished third and second in his next two starts. As a result, Darling made a couple of small changes to the colt's equipment for Saturday's Gold Series test.

"I changed his shoes, I put aluminum shoes on him to get a

little lighter shoe, and a little more grab, a little more reach. I let his hobbles out a little bit. It seemed to help. He's a big horse so he can go with a big hopple," Darling said. "He's just a massive horse, tall, but he's athletic, he's got that big shoulder and big hind end that you like. He's a horse that really stands out on the track. When you're out jogging him or training him he kind of catches everybody's eye."

In addition to the Ontario Sires Stakes, Beaumont Hanover is eligible to the Pepsi North America Cup (eliminations Aug. 22, final Aug. 29), Simcoe Stakes (Sept. 5) and the Somebeachsomewhere (Sept. 12). Darling said the colt is easy to train and, as long as he stays happy and healthy, should not need many overnight starts to remain sharp for his stakes engagements.

"You can train him all you want, he's good that way. Easy on himself, a fairly mild-mannered stud, never really acts up," said the trainer. "He spends an hour out in the paddock every morning from 6 to 7 am. He just loves that. You turn him out and he just trots down to the end of the paddock and starts eating grass for an hour, doesn't worry about anything. He's a classy horse."

Beaumont Hanover's Canadian season's mark would stand for just 90 minutes as **Tattoo Artist** roared around Woodbine Mohawk Park in 1:48.2 in the second \$107,200 Gold division.

Driver Louis-Philippe Roy sent Tattoo Artist straight to the front from Post 8, ringing up a sizzling :25.3 quarter. Keeping an eye peeled for the advance of fan favorite Indictable Hanover, Roy took his foot off the gas heading for the :54.1 and then let Tattoo Artist start to roll again when he caught sight of his rival heading for the 1:21.3 three-quarters. In spite of the sharp early pace, Tattoo Artist had something in reserve and pulled away to a three length victory in a Canadian season's record 1:48.2. Indictable Hanover settled for second and pocket-sitter Rhythm In Motion was third.

"He certainly stepped up tonight. I knew he was a fast little boy when we trained him down this spring, but that's pretty good to go that fast this time of year," said Dr. Ian Moore, who trains Tattoo Artist for Frank Cannon of Sanford, FL and Let It Ride Stables Inc. of Boca Raton, FL. "So I guess we're going to have to try to baby him along and save him for August, the big one I guess. He should do in there anyways."

Like Beaumont Hanover, Tattoo Artist is eligible for the North America Cup in August, and Moore said he will spend the coming days mapping out a schedule that aims to have the Hes Watching colt in peak form for Woodbine Mohawk Park's marquee event. Saturday's outing was the colt's fourth of his sophomore campaign and his third win.

"I gave him five days off after his last race (June 20), started back jogging him on Friday of last week, and then he had Sunday off as well, and then I trained him on Tuesday a mile and a half and he went the last half in the jog cart faster than I've ever been in my life, :56 and a bit," said the Cambridge resident. "That was the first time he had the ear plugs in. So he seemed very good going into this and hopefully we can keep him that way for a few more months anyway."

Tattoo Artist and Beaumont Hanover will return to Gold Series action on Saturday, July 25 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

Fireworks in sophomore pacing filly stakes at Hoosier

After a week's worth of Indiana Sires Stakes (ISS) action where favorites ruled the board, it was the 3-year-old pacing fillies turn in the spotlight at Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino on Saturday (July 4) and they provided the fireworks with upset victories in both divisions. Two \$33,500 divisions highlighted the evening's 14-race card that was held in front of spectators for the first time this season.

In the first division, Dale Hiteman steered **Rock It Out** to victory to spring the 23-1 upset. Utilizing a ground saving trip and a :26.2 closing kick, Rock It Out bested her rivals and stopped the timer in a new lifetime best of 1:51.4.

Grace Rocks and Sam Widger were the first to get a call through the opening panel in :27 but yielded the lead to the heavily favored Foxy Rigger and Trace Tetrack just before the half in :55.2. Rock It Out was well placed along the rail in third.

Foxy Rigger continued to call the shots through the three-quarters in 1:24.3 but the rest of the field was closing in quickly turning for home. Seventimesacharm and John DeLong were applying pressure from first-over but it was Rock It Out who was winding up to strike. Hiteman found late racing room and Rock It Out surged forward to get the win over Seventimesacharm by a head. Atoritotell and Peter Wrenn rallied well late in the lane to finish third. Rock It Out returned \$49.60 to win.

Trained by Donna Holt, Rock It Out recorded her fourth consecutive victory and remains undefeated at three. The daughter of Rockin Image—Musette Mindale pushed her lifetime earnings \$55,775 and is owned by D&R Racing Stable. Rock It Out was bred by Cornerstone Stock Farm.

In the second division of the stakes action, **Genie Rockwell**

and Marlin Fry utilized a similar ground saving strategy to pull the 13-1 upset. With a final quarter in an eye-popping :25.2., Genie Rockwell found late racing room up the inside and powered home a winner to stop the timer in a new lifetime best of 1:50.2.

Heavily favorited Priceless and Brandon Bates went straight to the front through the opening panel in :26.4. Mystical Carrie and Trace Tetrack grabbed a pocket seat while Genie Rockwell settled along the rail in third. Bates was able to slow the tempo just a touch as Priceless clicked off fractions of :56.1 and 1:24.2. When the field turned for home, Mystical Carrie tipped from the pocket and was able to stick a nose in front of Priceless. Just as Mystical Carrie stuck a nose in front, Fry found late racing room and Genie Rockwell found another gear. Genie Rockwell got the win by a quarter of a length over Mystical Carrie. Priceless finished third. Genie Rockwell returned \$28.40 to win.

Trained by James Yoder, Genie Rockwell has now won two of three starts this season and pushed her lifetime bankroll to \$58,185. The daughter of Always A Virgin—Norma Rockwell is owned by Marlin Fry who also bred the filly with Glen Hershberger.

Filion pilots trio of freshman pacers to Grassroots victory

Two-year-old pacing colts invaded Woodbine Mohawk Park on Monday evening (July 6), starring in six \$23,000 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots divisions and No Better Joy kicked off the provincial campaign in style with an impressive 1:52.1 victory.

Starting from the outside Post 9, driver Bob McClure settled **No Better Joy** in fourth as Flash Cube took the field to a :27.2 opening quarter. Heading for the :56.2 half McClure put the fan favorite on the front, but Flash Cube stepped up to apply pressure before the 1:24.3 three-quarters. At the top of the stretch it looked as though Flash Cube would prevail, but No Better Joy shifted into another gear and came back on for a head victory. Flash Cube settled for second and Cantstoplying closed well to be third.

"I've never had a horse, like even when you're training at the farm and when you come to the top of the stretch, even if there's another set 20 or 30 lengths ahead, he always puts it in another gear to chase them, so I think he kind of seen that horse and he picked it up again," said Nicky Comegna, who trains No Better Joy for his father Bruno Comegna of Burlington, ON. "He's always had that attitude, that's why I

liked him."

Comegna's son Jordan picked No Better Joy out at last fall's London Selected Yearling Sale, offering up \$46,000 for the Betterthancheddar son. The youngster impressed his connections all winter, but a few hiccups in qualifying action and his first race made Comegna opt for the Grassroots rather than the July 3 Gold Series event.

"If he had gone good last week we were going to put him in on Friday, but I just couldn't justify throwing him in there after that interference break (June 26)," said Nicky. "So I figured we'd maybe get him in a little easier and see if we do have something that can go a little bit, you know. Believe it or not it gave him an extra two, three days to kind of forget about last week, and it worked out."

McClure closed the Grassroots portion of the evening with another victory, guiding Shadow Play son **Lawless Shadow** to a 1:53 score for trainer Dr. Ian Moore of Cambridge, ON and his partners R G McGroup Ltd. of Bathurst, NB, Serge Savard of St-Bruno, QC and Frank Cannon of Sanford, FL. Bulldog Hanover was hot on the heels of the fan favorite in second and Wisk Key K completed the top three.

Driver Sylvain Filion captured three Grassroots divisions, kicking off his hat trick in the second \$23,150 contest with fan favorite **Uncontrollable**. The Control The Moment son delivered the largest margin of victory in the Grassroots divisions, reaching the wire six and one-half lengths ahead of Candy Trader and Watch My Beverage in 1:53.

"He told me a couple of days ago that he was really high on him. He said he probably made a mistake, he should have probably put him in the Gold, so it made me pretty high on him too, you know," said Filion of the Scott McEneny trainee. "He was actually very, very nice. I left with him, then I pulled again around the last turn and he just cruised home."

Like No Better Joy, Uncontrollable will likely make the jump up to the Gold Series for his second Ontario Sires Stakes start. McEneny, who also owns the \$6,000 yearling purchase, noted that a strong showing against the top colts on July 18 could see Uncontrollable supplemented to the Battle Of Waterloo Eliminations at Grand River Raceway on July 27.

"I think I'm going to give him a shot. You know what, he's better off a helmet. You can see he buzzed around them really quick and then he kind of got a little lazy, but I think if you can keep him covered up he can pace with any of them," said McEneny. "Like I said, first start, with a big drop time-wise, and he did it right, so I'm pretty happy with him."

Filion was back in the winner's circle after the third division with Betterthancheddar son **Brilliant Corners**, who

sat fourth before stepping out to mount an attack on pacesetting favorite West Coast Kid. Brilliant Corners sprinted home to a 1:54.2 victory, one and three-quarter lengths ahead of his [TheStable.ca](#) stablemate First Glance. Frank Deford was four and one-quarter lengths back in third.

“He was a bit of a hot-headed horse early on and I was able to sit him in the hole in the qualifiers, but he was really strong, headstrong you know, and he wouldn’t really relax, but tonight he was as good as I’ve ever seen him. Calm, relaxed and I was able to sit him in the hole as long as I wanted and that’s the reason why he was so strong at the end of the mile,” said Filion. “He’s learning – it’s still a learning process with the 2-year-olds – but every time I sat behind him he got better and better, so I hope he keeps going.”

Filion engineered the win for trainer Harry Poulton and fractional ownership group TheStable Brilliant Corners of Guelph, ON.

Filion completed the hat trick in the fifth division with **Saratoga Blue Chip**, who was as headstrong as Brilliant Corners was relaxed. The Hes Watching son gave Filion a workout as he sat in the pocket behind Mr Charisma, but had enough left to get home for a one-half length win over Beach Blogger. Mr Charisma finished third in the 1:53.3 mile.

“When he left the gate he was half a runaway. I had a hard time to hold him and I had to re-move him to the front, and then I had to take a huge hold of him again to let James (MacDonald, with Mr Charisma) go by, and then moved him again around the end of the last turn. So it wasn’t the greatest drive, but it worked out anyway,” said Filion with a rueful chuckle. “He stretched my arms pretty good.”

Filion piloted Saratoga Blue Chip to the win for trainer Anthony Beaton and owner Larry Menary of Branchton, Michael Guerriero of Brampton, Alan Alber of Thornhill, ON and George Harrison of Wanee Walton, England.

Avion Seelster took the other division with a 1:53.2 victory over Lil Red Sportsstar and Warrawee Wazzup. Jody Jamieson piloted the Sportswriter colt to the win for owner-trainer Jack Darling.

“There’s a good group of Grassrooters. Wow, it’s amazing how fast they go,” said Filion of the freshman colt season opener. “The weather is so warm, and no wind at all and the track is perfect, so it makes for speed.”

The 2-year-old pacing colts will return to Woodbine Mohawk Park on July 20 for their second Grassroots start.

Marcus Melander baby colts win 2 of 3 PA All-Stars

Two more trotting colts from the seemingly-endless line produced by the Marcus Melander stable were among the three winners of \$30,000 divisions of the Pennsylvania All-Stars event for freshmen conducted Monday afternoon (July 6) at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

The faster of the two winners from Melander, last year’s Trainer of the Year, was the colt **In Range**, by Bar Hopping out of Ilia (the dam of \$400G+ winners Tight Lines and Long Tom). Tim Tetrick hustled the baby away from the rail, kept him in line when he suffered some “Pocono paddock greenness” coming off the first turn (where the Pocono paddock is), yielded to stablemate Incentive for the two-hole, then came up the inside in the stretch to catch his barnmate by 1¾ lengths in 1:55.1. The fast freshman is owned by AMG Stable Inc., Kenneth Kjellgren, Tomas Asell, and Rick Wahlstadt.

The other Melander victory went to the Father Patrick colt out of Southern Senorita (dam of millionaire Guccio), **Bidensky**, who stopped the timer in 1:55.3. Marcus’s younger brother Mattias was willing to keep Bidensky three-wide most of the first turn in order to get the lead, and he maintained a comfortable margin the rest of the way, with a late-closing Tart Tongue only getting as close as 1¼ lengths away at the finish. Bidensky is owned by Brixton Medical Inc.

Both the Melander youngsters were betting favorites; the third winner, **Southwind Mazzarati**, rewarded his backers with an 11-1 payoff. The Southwind Frank colt out of Alix Hall (dam of the \$900G+ winner Flex The Muscle) got the lead at the quarter under Andrew McCarthy’s handling, could rate a 1:00 middle half, then sprinted home in :28.4 to complete a 1:58.2 mile that saw Arnold N Dicky 1½ lengths in back of him at the wire. The Lucas Wallin pupil is co-owned by his trainer, Mazza Racing Stables LLC, and Stormi And Bruiser Stables.

Driver Tyler Buter had four wins on the card, one of them with **Wild Bill**, a son of Somebeachsomewhere–Wild West Show, making him a full brother to world champion Huntsville. The long-memored may recall that this horse showed the potential of a world-beater at the dawn of his career in mid-2017, but fate has not been kind to him until today, when he rushed to the lead at the half and went on to victory in a lifetime best 1:50.2. It’s hard to believe that the promising baby here achieved just the sixth triumph of his career, but maybe now is his time for owner/trainer Ray Schnitker.

Trotting fillies rewrite Clinton Raceway record books

Forty-eight sophomore trotting fillies descended on Clinton Raceway Sunday afternoon and the track record at the half-mile oval fell not once, but twice as the fillies battled in six \$22,800 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots divisions.

As the program got underway the 3-year-old trotting filly track record stood at 1:59.3, set by Gotta Pay To Play in a July 2018 Grassroots event. That speed mark was erased in the third division when **Moana** wore down pacesetter Credits Celebrity and out-sprinted fan favorite Alexa Blue Chip to claim a two-length victory in 1:59.2. Alexa Blue Chip settled for second and Credits Celebrity was third.

"I knew she'd be pretty good there compared to some of the other ones, because she gets around the turns like a hoop around a barrel, so I knew that would play in her favour overall," said trainer Shawn Steacy. "And James had been taking her back and racing her conservatively the last couple starts, so I figured he'd be pressing pretty good off the gate and trying to be aggressive with her today."

James MacDonald engineered the Muscle Mass daughter's first win of 2020 for owners Landmark 12 Racing Stable of Lansdowne, 1187422 Ontario Inc. of Ottawa, ON and Hudson Standardbred Stable Inc. of Hudson, QC. Moana was a two-time Grassroots winner at two, including a win in her Grassroots Semi-final, and Steacy hopes the filly is poised to match or better her freshman success this season.

"She's always been a little bit on the aggressive side and I thought we were going to have trouble training her back with her aggression this year, but once we got about 10 or 15 training miles into her she settled right in and she trained back a lot better, a lot easier on herself, than I expected her to be," Steacy explained. "In the long run of things she'll be better because she'll be able to conserve a lot more of her energy that way."

Moana's name would stay in Clinton's record book for less than two hours however as **Profound Paragon** and driver Jean Bernard Renaud laid down a gate-to-wire 1:59 effort in the final division. Another daughter of Muscle Mass, Profound Paragon hit the wire one and three-quarter lengths ahead of fan favorite Hickman County and Sheer Energy.

The win was Profound Paragon's second straight and her fourth of the sophomore campaign. A late bloomer, the filly did not make her first start until after the Ontario Sires Stakes season was complete last fall, but she showed enough promise that trainer Julie Walker and her co-owner

Steven Titus of Manalapan, NJ were confident she would be a player on the Grassroots circuit this summer.

"We were going to give her the month of February off so that we didn't tire her out for the Sires Stakes season and with that month off and COVID on top of that, she really got thick, she grew up a lot. She's not really tall, but she got strong," said Walker. "With the little break and everything we were able to take the trotting hobbles off her, and like I said she just kept getting stronger and better."

"Our plan was always just the Grassroots because I'm not sure if she's a high speed filly, but like you see today, she can go around any shape and size track and that's kind of fun to have. And she's very smart, even going to the races today, it's hot, and she just sits and falls asleep in the cross-ties, and just likes to do her job."

Dancing Queen kicked off the Grassroots action with a 2:01 score for driver Brett MacDonald, trainer Ron MacDonald and owner Synerco Ventures Inc. of Toronto, ON. St Helens and No Angel Here finished one and one-quarter lengths behind the Royalty For Life daughter, who was making her Ontario Sires Stakes debut.

The second split went to **Validation** and driver Colin Kelly, who controlled the tempo from start to finish, sailing under the wire one and three-quarter lengths ahead of fan favorite Chelseas Magic. Incredible Hally was five lengths back in third.

"She trained down so well and then she just kind of got into a couple bad habits where she'd get excited behind the gate. She just needed some time. She's very big and growthy so she just needed some time to mature I think," said Kelly, who piloted the Muscle Mass daughter to her second sophomore win for trainer Rick Zeron of Oakville and his partner Howard Taylor of Philadelphia, PA. "She did everything well within hand today, she didn't seem overly stressed and she seemed to do everything pretty easy and relaxed. Hopefully she just kind of builds on that and she can have a good season going forward."

The Present captured the fourth division with a 2:02.4 effort for Bob McClure, trainer Marcel Barrieau of Cambridge and his partner Gestion Mastel of Longueuil, QC. Peppas Angel finished three lengths back in second and Queen M was three more behind in third.

"She's a very square-gaited trotter, perfect for a track like Clinton," said McClure of the Royalty For Life daughter. "It's tough to beat her on the small tracks."

The fifth Grassroots battle went to a hard-charging **Noblesse Duharas**, who overcame an early break caused by

interference to claim the 2:02 victory. Need An Alibi finished second and fan favorite Highland Foxytrotr was third.

"She raced super today. She got interfered with in the first turn and got mixed up, but then raced fantastic to come back and win," said Scott Young, who piloted the Muscle Mass daughter to the win for trainer Denis Gueriel and owner Haras De L'Estrie Inc. of Dunham, QC. "I was super happy with her performance today."

The focus shifted to the 3-year-old pacing fillies at the end of the program as the \$64,700 Kin Pace Final went postward in Race 10. A big closing effort by **Watch My Speed** and driver Jody Jamieson saw them claim the victor's spoils as favorites High Roller Duke and Tuggingoncredit hooked wheels in the stretch, interfering with eventual runner-up Century Gianna and taking themselves out of the race. Preeminence recovered from an early break to finish third.

While they could not be trackside to cheer on the fillies, Clinton Raceway fans wagered just over \$88,000 on the program.

The three-year-old trotting fillies will make their second Grassroots start on July 26 at Rideau Carleton Raceway.

In the \$57,000 second division, the morning line favorite is Blank Stare (Corey Callahan). The gelding by Bolt The Duer is two for two this season including a NYSS win at Tioga Downs. Trained by John Butenschoen, he is five for nine in his

career.

Groovy Joe (Matt Kakaley) is the top earner in the group with over \$230,000 in the bank. The colt by Roll with Joe had seven wins and three seconds in 10 starts as a freshman. Trained by Blake Macintosh, he is winless in three starts as a 3-year-old.

The other top rival is the Rob Harmon trained American Rebel (Tyler Buter). The colt by American Ideal has a second place finish in two starts this season. Overall he has five career wins with over \$140,000 earned.

Shenandoah Downs fall harness season to kick off Sept. 18

The fifth annual harness racing season at Shenandoah Downs will kick off Sept. 18 and continue through Oct. 17 with racing scheduled every Friday at 3:30 p.m. and Saturday at 2 p.m.. Parking and admission are free and the races are family friendly.

Shenandoah may be one of the few tracks in the country whose planned purse distribution and season length will not be affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. Between \$45,000-\$50,000 in purse money will be given away on average daily, and the meet will extend over five weekends, as planned initially.

A slate of Virginia Breeder's elimination and championship races will be held over three consecutive Saturdays at their announced purse levels. Three-year-old elims for pacers and trotters of both sexes will be contested on Sept.19 followed by 2-year-old elims the next Saturday. The annual Championship showcase program will be held Oct.3 for both age groups and feature \$40,000-plus purses for each of those eight different finals. A series of Virginia Breeder's aged stakes will complement the freshmen and sophomore stakes that afternoon.

Due to potential COVID-19-related restrictions, there will not be wagering on the races this year. "We want to err on the side of caution," said Virginia Harness Horseman's Association executive director Debbie Warnick. "At this point, we can only have limited attendance at the races and feel it is in the best interest of everyone to not offer wagering. Betting stations are only available in a small concourse area and we don't think social distancing guidelines could safely be adhered to with a constant flow of traffic heading to and from the betting area each race."

Shenandoah Downs does not uplink its races to simulcast locations yet and relies solely on fans betting at the track. Plans are for pari-mutuel wagering to resume in 2021.

Racing applications for horsepeople are now available online at vhha.net and shenandoahdowns.com and must be turned in by Aug. 9. The barn area will open Monday Sept. 14 and the track will be open for training beginning that day. Draws will take place on Tuesday for Friday cards and on Wednesday for Saturday programs. Dee Lineweaver returns as director of racing for the third straight season.

Shenandoah Downs is located in Woodstock, VA, halfway between Harrisonburg and Winchester off I-81 at Exit 283 in the scenic Shenandoah Valley. For questions, call Debbie Warnick at 443-463-0917.
