Owner Brad Grant reflects on Bulldog Hanover's 1:46 WORLD RECORD

The Jack Darling trainee joins Always B Miki and Lather Up as the fastest horses in harness racing history.

After the smoke cleared last weekend at The Meadowlands, the sport's third 1:46 pacer took his place in the record books, alongside world champions Always B Miki and Lather Up. In the second division of Saturday's \$99,500 Roll With Joe Open Pace, Allywag Hanover (Todd McCarthy) was first off the gate, with 1-5 favorite Bulldog Hanover (Dexter Dunn) in hot pursuit to the :26.2 opening quarter, then gliding past at the :53.4 half. When first-over Abuckabett Hanover (Tim Tetrack) loomed a closer third near three-quarters, Bulldog Hanover shifted into another gear, confidently holding off Allywag with a :25.3 last panel.

Every horse in the field of seven paced home in :26 or faster, which makes Bulldog Hanover's world record somewhat different from those of Always B Miki (in the 2016 Allera Farm

Open at Red Mile) and Lather Up (in the 2019 Dennis Drazin Graduate Series Final at The Meadowlands). Only Backstreet Shadow (third to Lather Up) closed in sub-:26 style in either of the other two world champion's record miles, while Bulldog Hanover (Shadow Play-BJ's Squall) outsprinted a wall of late speed.

Bulldog Hanover's part-owner Brad Grant was not at The Meadowlands for his stallion's fourth-consecutive victory.

"I was watching it from home," the Milton, ON resident said. "I thought he had a good shot of winning the race, but I didn't think he had a 1:46 in him. When they hit the three-quarter pole and they were still going at it, the way the horses had been coming home all night... I think about halfway down the lane, I was wishing I could've seen the teletimer, because I figured it was getting close."

Although Noel Daley handles training duties south of the border, "It's really Jack Darling and his people that put this horse together and made him the horse he is," said Grant. "Jack was good enough to let me get on the wagon and be part of it. I'm just a cheerleader – the credit needs to go to other people." Grant joined Cambridge, ON-based Darling as co-owner prior to Bulldog Hanover's 3-year-old season, in which the colt won 10 of 15 starts, including three Ontario Sires Stakes Gold legs, a Somebeachsomewhere division, and his North America Cup elimination at home track Woodbine Mohawk Park.

"I've done business with Jack in the past and I had watched [Bulldog Hanover] as a 2-year-old. We tell the story that I gave Jack a call and said if there were any interests [available], I'd be interested. Five minutes later, we had a deal done. That's just the way Jack and I both work, on a handshake and a verbal [agreement]. That was it, and since then it's been a lot of fun.

"I bought horses from Jack in the past and had some real good luck. They come from a good barn, good quality racehorses."

The high-speed Ontario-sired son is Canada's fastest-ever older stallion on a half-mile track, having won a May 15 elimination for Flamboro Downs' Charles Juravinski Memorial Cup in 1:49.3h.

Bulldog Hanover was "very well received" in his first season standing stud at Seelster Farms in Lucan, ON, which overlapped with his 4-year-old racing campaign.

"Jack and I believe that he didn't get enough credit [in 2021], and probably that's one of the reasons both he and I believed he would be a great older horse," said Grant. "It was Jack that came forward with the idea that we look at breeding him...The horse only goes about 10 minutes up the road to the clinic [to be

collected]. He does his thing and comes back. He goes about his business. He's a professional, on the track, in the barn, and in the breeding shed."

Grant said he considered the stallion's 2021 North America Cup elimination to be his best performance.

"After that race, I truly believed we had the winner of the North America Cup. And I don't usually go into a race overconfident, but I might have, on that one."

Desperate Man won the 2021 NA Cup. Bulldog Hanover was fourth. But when some top sophomore pacers' careers were winding down, Darling and Grant's colt was only getting started.

"He raced late in the fall at Hoosier and he went in :48 in the mud [winning a division of the Circle City on Oct. 29]. After the race, Ron Burke texted me and he said: 'Great mile on a good track. He's a 1:46 horse.' I just thought, 'Well, that's pretty fast. And when the horse crossed the wire the other night, I turned to my wife and said, 'Remember that text from Ron, when he said if that had been a [fast] track, he'd have gone in 1:46? Maybe he saw something we didn't.' To do it last Saturday night, one of the first things that went through my mind was his message to me when he won that stake race in the mud."

There is only one Canadian mile among current major world records – it's Dr J Hanover's 1:46.4s mark for 4-year-old geldings, set in a Graduate Series leg on June 3, 2017 at Mohawk. Grant also shared ownership of that world champion, witnessing his record mile in person.

"Just luckily enough, I was there that night," he said. "Coming off the turn they were flying, and coming down the lane they were flying. I was kind of watching the teletimer and watching the race. I thought he was going to hit around 1:47. That was just an exciting, exciting race. [Trainer] Tony [Alagna] believed

that the horse had more speed in him than he had ever shown. He showed it that day.”

Dr J Hanover’s mark at $\frac{7}{8}$ -mile Mohawk is a little ironic.

“I think he was a half-mile specialist. I got him a little later in life, but you know, Tony always felt that in his day, he was probably one of the best half-milers,” said Grant. The Somebeachsomewhere—So Perfect gelding’s fastest victory on a half was a 1:51.1h win at Yonkers, two years after taking his Mohawk mark, but he enjoyed success in three legs of the 2018 George Morton Levy Series, finishing fifth in the final.

In 2019, “the partners and I all agreed it was time to retire him. [Trainer] Tony’s mom [Donna Lee] has him as a riding horse. Donna loved the horse all the way along, so it was a perfect fit.”

Dr J Hanover’s former owner added that he expects Woodbine Mohawk Park’s overall track record will fall in coming years. Maybe this one.

“I think it will. We have to keep in mind, the horses are getting faster. They’re elite athletes – they’re not just horses. Under the right conditions, you know, Dr J’s record will be broken. There’s no doubt about it. Hopefully by Bulldog Hanover. Records are made to be broken. Some of them aren’t, but for the most part, the way the tracks are being looked after, and the way the horses are being looked after, breeding for speed and everything else, it’s gonna come.”

That doesn’t mean it will be easy.

“Everything has to be perfect,” Grant said. “When [tracks] get the big races going, they may tend to pay a little more attention or give a little more TLC to the track [surface]. If the weather’s right,

the temperature’s right... everything. Look at the miles on Saturday night [at The Meadowlands], Rockyroad Hanover, :46.2. I owned him at one time too. It was just a perfect night for racing.”

Bulldog Hanover is the current big dog in his division, with the \$250,000 final of the Graduate Series next on the dance card.

“As long as the horse is healthy and able to compete, then I think you’ll see him in all the big races this year,” said Grant. “He’s got the Graduate final this weekend [July 9 at The Meadowlands], and then he’s got the William Haughton [Memorial], July 16 at The Meadowlands. At Woodbine Mohawk Park this October, it all comes down to the 2022 Breeders Crown for the Bulldog. It’s always nice to win it on home turf – it just seems to be tougher.”

While many in the industry consider earnings the better measure of a horse than a fast mark, world records still have meaning, even in the era of abundant speed. What does a 1:46 flat mile mean today, to Grant?

“It means you’ve got a damn good racehorse!”

Pace eliminations and Graduate finals take center stage

So far, the sophomore pacing colts are a competitive group, but not particularly fast.

Now into July, it's still hard to know what to make of this year's crop of 3-year-old colt pacers. With 16 (scratched down to 15) colt and gelding sophomores entered for the Meadowlands Pace eliminations this weekend and without any clear standout, the group is a hyper competitive one. But at least so far, it isn't a hyper fast one.

Last month's North America Cup at Woodbine Mohawk Park was won in a time of 1:50. That mark represents the first time since 2004 (Mantacular) in which the race didn't go in a sub 1:50 clocking, and was only the second time that's happened in the last 20 years. That said, the winner of that race, Pebble Beach, would have gone into the Meadowlands Pace as the favorite if he had been nominated to the event and would have gone faster too.

With Pebble Beach not included, that left the horse Hammering Hank listed #1 by the Meadowlands on their Road to the Meadowlands Pace rankings. Regrettably, it was announced following Tuesday's draw that he would have to scratch due to a condylar fracture. With two races this year in which I think it's fair to say didn't quite yet measure up to himself as a 2-year-old, the fact that he was ranked on top shows just how wide open this year's edition of the Pace is.

If there was future wagering established at the FanDuel Sportsbook at the Meadowlands for the Pace (why isn't there?), here's what the odds to win the Pace final might have looked like going into tomorrow's eliminations.

Beach Glass +400: A top contender and will be made so by the public, though still waiting for a "wow" type of mile from him. He makes his third start since picking up Gingras and just his ninth overall lifetime start, so maybe he's still figuring things out.

Night Hawk +450: He fought Pebble Beach bravely in his North America Cup elimination and then I was surprised that Miller didn't leave with him at all in the final. He hasn't raced since, so could be a bit of a question.

Greatest Ending +500: From the same trainer and driver connections as last year's winner Lawless Shadow, he could be any kind. He should get much credit for beating Night Hawk in his first start of the season and depending on how things go this weekend, he could potentially be the favorite in next week's final.

I Did It Myway +600: That was a breakout win for him last week in 1:48.1 where times across the entire weekend at the Meadowlands were unbelievably fast. McCarthy picked up the drive on him in the North America Cup final and this one has always been of higher regard.

Captain Cowboy +800: Dunn and Svanstedt teamed up last week with a monster stateside debut from Alrajah One It and this one could be better than generally perceived. He had pace last week from the pocket in the Messenger final but wasn't able to accelerate until too late; he's much better than early season record indicates.

Mad Max Hanover +1000: This one was Tetricks's surprising pick over I Did It Myway in the North America Cup final, so maybe he knows something. He was awesome in a couple races at Pocono in May; talent could be there.

Frozen Hanover + 1200: \$325,000 yearling outraced his odds in the North America Cup final and tuned up for this with a win over the track last week. Connections have surprised here before.

Caviart Camden +1500: Still waiting for him to come back to that 2-year-old form. Last week's race was interesting though as he pounced first-over, fell back about five lengths, and then came back on again in the stretch to miss by about a length.

Early Action +1500: Almost the same could be said for him as for Caviart Camden. Connections shouldn't be ignored and I could be too quick to sell but looks like a longshot at present time.

Field (all others) +2000: Atlas Hanover picked up the winner's cover in the Messenger final but couldn't keep up when it counted. Captainryanmichael takes a shot for trainer Pavia but it's a giant step up; good front-end try five back against Caviart Camden, though. Fouever Boy didn't make much noise in the North America Cup when starting from the rail in both his elimination and final; did surprise in a PASS race at Pocono in May. Market Based was well positioned but tired in his North America Cup elimination as a longshot and didn't threaten last week in his prep for this. Nautical Hanover hasn't been disgraced against these types but is just 3 for 19 life; was okay late in the Messenger last week. PJ Lou has threatened against these on occasion, trainer Harder is just 1 for 26 at the Meadowlands this year.

THOUGHTS ON GRADUATE SERIES FINALS

Race 2 mares trot: Four of these five rematch from the most recent Graduate leg at the end of June. In that race, Bella Bellini sat an unhurried last through slow fractions and it still didn't matter as she swept in the stretch. Carded early as race two while there's still daylight, maybe the only question is if Bellini can break 1:50. She came close last week when beating older rivals in the Six Pack.

Race 8 mares pace: It's not too often you see horses close in :24.3 and :25.3 in consecutive weeks and lose both, but such is what happened to Test Of Faith. Actually, that :25.3 quarter last week was even more impressive than the :24 and change one from the week prior, considering the overland and first-over trip from post 10 in which she never saw the rail. Mikala was able to keep her perfect season intact when she gamely fended off Test Of Faith the last time they met. Not sure she'll be able to get away with a :55.3 first half this time around. Oakwoodanabella IR is the other obvious contender though wasn't quite strong enough to get past Mikala or hold off Test Of Faith two weeks ago.

Race 9 open trot: Rattle My Cage has improved markedly between age 3 and 4, and that was a well-earned win last out in a Graduate leg coming off the pocket trip. Cuatro De Julio has been trotting smooth of late and shouldn't have much issue getting to the front despite the outside post; throws it down again in a rematch with #6. Ahundreddollarbill found the older Open trotters a bit too much and now is back to a more reasonable spot. Sonofamistery has had his moments here.

Race 11 open pace: What more can you say about the 1:46 mile last week from Bulldog Hanover? The time was one thing, but just as impressive was making Allywag Hanover look ordinary from the pocket and did the same two back to Linedrive Hanover. Has the major post edge on his closest competition. Rockyroad Hanover exploded off second-over cover en route to his fast 1:46.2 win last week but now moves to post 10. Charlie May had to go first-over into fast fractions last week and did well to hold on for second; this is the same post he had almost one year ago in his first-past-the-post Meadowlands Pace.

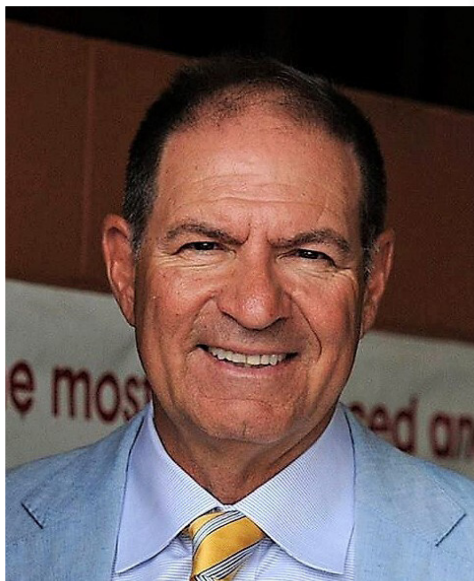

Lucien Fontaine selected to the Hall of Fame; Frank Antonacci, Per Eriksson on the ballot

The Hall of Fame Screening Committee of the United States Harness Writers Association (USHWA), after meeting with a select group of Harness Racing Museum Trustees, announces that Lucien Fontaine has been elected to the Harness Racing Hall of Fame, through a Veterans designation, and that Frank "The Elder" Antonacci and Per Eriksson would be the Hall of Fame ballot candidates for this summer's election.

Fontaine becomes a direct member of the Hall of Fame through the Veterans provision, which permits the Screening Committee to make a direct assignment of a person 70 years of age or older who has made a truly notable contribution to harness racing.

Lucien "Loosh" Fontaine was a successful horseman and an innovator in helping improve the lot of his fellow horsemen. Fontaine began his career in his native Quebec as a groom for the legendary Keith Waples, then emigrated to the United States and worked for Clint Hodgins at the time of Bye Bye Byrd's ascendancy. He then took the step of becoming solely a catch-driver for other trainers, in an era some 60 years ago when "trainer/driver" was almost thought of as one word.

Fontaine prospered on the toughest circuit of all in that era, the Roosevelt/Yonkers wheel in New York City, for many years. In 1986, he worked with a special horse in Forrest Skipper, that

season's Horse of the Year who traveled from coast-to-coast and went undefeated in 15 starts. Fontaine had to retire from driving at age 49 due to open heart surgery, but still he had amassed 3,458 driving wins, and the horses he drove had earned \$21,236,952.

Perhaps not as well-known, but making a major impact behind the scenes, are Fontaine's many contributions that secured and helped his fellow horsemen and racing, certainly standardbred racing but also reaching over to the thoroughbred side. Fontaine served as vice-president of the National Association of Harness Drivers, and on the board of directors of the New York Standardbred Owners Association (SOANY) and the rules committee of the New York State Racing Commission. He was an early advocate and then "point man" for pre-race testing for both the New York racing breeds; the 5 per cent "drivers commission" being taken out by the track and reserved just for the driver (borrowing from thoroughbred jockey practice); and long-term insurance and pensions for horsemen.

Antonacci and Eriksson will go before the Hall of Fame voters, who are made up of eligible members of USHWA and all members of the Hall Of Fame, this summer. If they secure 75 per cent of the yes-no votes of the electorate, they will join Fontaine as inductees to the Hall next summer.

Also on the summer ballot will be Communicators Hall Of Fame candidates Bob Roberts and Ken Warkentin, to be voted on by USHWA.

Frank Gerald Antonacci, known as “The Elder,” has carried on the tradition established by family members and Hall Of Famers Guy “Sonny” Antonacci and “Big Frank” Antonacci with the Crown Stables, the latter making its mark initially with the likes of Lindy’s Pride and Speedy Crown, and today primarily with Lindy Farms, the 2021 Stan Bergstein/Proximity Award winner, the highest honor solely voted on by USHWA, and the 2020 Service To Youth Award from the Harness Horse Youth Foundation.

Frank and his brother Jerry, through their management of Lindy Farms, have made its impact felt in all areas of the sport. As owner, Lindy Farms horses include Hall Of Fame horses Moni Maker and Cantab Hall, five other seasonal champions, three Hambletonian winners, and several Breeders Crowns wearers. The Antonacci/Lindy connections have bred or owned nine millionaire racehorses.

Lindy has been associated with such premier stallions as Lindy Lane, Cantab Hall, Crazyed, International Moni and Walner, the latter two, the most recent of their studs, being part of a development of cross-Atlantic breeding the operation had pioneered in the 1990s

Frank has served as a director of the Hambletonian Society since 1993 and a trustee of the Harness Racing Museum and Hall of Fame since 2011; he also was a director of the U.S. Trotting Association for 19 years. Many of the next generations of Antonaccis are in the sport, some working in programs designed to help those really in need of several types of personal support.

Per Eriksson made his mark in the highest reaches of the sport as a very young trainer after coming to North America from his native Sweden. His talents as a caretaker and assistant trainer quickly identified him as a developing master horseman, and by the age of 32 Eriksson had already trained three horses to success in the biggest North American trotting race, the Hambletonian: Prakas (his “foundation horse” at age 24), Giant Victory, and Alf Palema. He also won such important races as five Breeders Crowns, two Kentucky Futurities, four World Trotting Derbys, and a Yonkers Trot with such champions as Credit Winner, Lookout Victory, Bullville Victory, and Tejano, as well as “revitalizing” Davidia Hanover, a champion early in her career whom Eriksson helped bring back to form by introducing the then-“European practice” of continually going long jogging sessions to cart, helping to restore his confidence.

At age 39, Eriksson then decided to transfer his mercurial North American success back to his native Sweden, with his family supporting him. He has worked as a successful trainer in Scandinavia since, surfacing with such horses as Royal Fighter, an Elitloppet competitor and heat winner in 2018. But his 20-year rapid rise to the pinnacle of North American trotting success, showing the care and craftsmanship of veterans nearly twice his age, remains his signal accomplishment.

Mikaela Del Giudice ecstatic about her first training win

Mikaela Del Giudice's first training win was somewhat of a wait and see moment.

As the field straightened for home in the fifth race on the night of June 28 at Running Aces, it appeared Zanetti, a 6-year-old son of A Rocknroll Dance—Tys Artist, had a legitimate chance to take all the spoils in the pace with a purse of \$13,000.

If the bay was going to cross the wire first, the woman who owns and trains the original \$21,000 purchase at the 2017 Lexington Sale knew exactly how it was going to play out.

"It wasn't a very fast time for him," started Del Giudice, of the 1:54.2 mile "He wasn't tired after the race. He is one that will not win by more than he has to. (Driver) Nick (Roland) said that as soon as he passed the other horses, his ears went up and he started looking around at the scenery."

Del Giudice was far more focused than Zanetti, who was bred by Jim Winske and made his debut in the barn of Richard Magee on June 4, 2019, finishing second.

She was also far more composed than any of those who had wagered on the 5-1 gelding.

"It was definitely the most excited I've ever been, but I'm always pretty reserved. I was definitely celebrating a lot internally, but I think I jumped up and down, which is the most I've ever done at a horse race."

Del Giudice was still sporting a smile well after the official sign was posted on the tote board.

Over one week after the milestone victory, she still finds herself replaying the final strides to the wire.

"I told my mom a couple of days later that it hadn't really sunk in yet. Now it has and it's really special."

Del Giudice, who works alongside Magee – they have eight horses currently in their barn – jumped at the chance to take over the training reins with a horse she knows well.

Zanetti was a big reason behind the decision by Del Giudice to earn her trainer's license.

The idea to join the conditioner ranks, however, wasn't in the works for a long time.

"In around March of this year, I decided to get my trainer's license, just on a whim. I was out at The Meadows, so I studied and took the written test there. I moved to Running Aces for the season and did my practical here and got everything signed off. It just made sense that I would train Zanetti because I was doing all the work on him. He was making his first start back in a few weeks. He had raced hard at The Meadows, so we wanted to give him a couple of weeks off. He was in an Open 2 and Nick gave him a great drive."

Becoming part of the racing scene wasn't a life's goal for Del Giudice. Instead, it was, at first, a chance to earn some money over the summer months when she was in high school.

In fact, there was a time she didn't even know what Running Aces was about.

That all changed in 2011.

“I grew up right near Forest Lake, Minnesota. Running Aces opened in 2008 and I actually didn't know what it was for the longest time. Three years later, I was looking for a summer high school job, and I went looking for work at Running Aces. I started out with the DeLong family, worked that summer, had a blast, and then went back for my senior year of high school. I figured that was it. The next summer, Rick Magee was looking for help and I had just graduated. I helped all that summer, and as they say, it just gets in your blood, so the rest is history. I've been doing it full time since then. I went to one year of college, locally, in St. Paul, and after that, I transferred to Oregon State, and took my courses online so that I could travel around to race. I got my bachelor's degree (in Agricultural Science) and I've been racing horses ever since.”

Del Giudice's main goal, in the short term, is working to see Zanetti in the final of the Dan Patch free-for-all race, scheduled for July 24 at Running Aces.

The lifetime winner of 15 races who has banked nearly \$200,000 in earnings has a few miles to travel before that becomes a reality.

“It's coming up pretty fast. He'll have two races in the open, and eliminations after that, so hopefully, he'll do well and he can race in the final. That's our main focus right now.”

Another important key for Del Giudice is in honing her craft.

“I think that was what was hanging me up from getting my trainer's license. I thought, 'I have so much to learn, and I don't know nearly everything yet.' I finally realized that I'm never going to know everything and that I can learn as much as I can every day. That's why I decided to go for it. And even though I do have my license, I'm still going to work even harder at learning new skills.”

Horse racing isn't the only calling for Del Giudice.

She has her own company, Mik Digital Marketing Co., which specializes in harness racing marketing, including sales, stallions, and farms, but also offers a course for small business owners to learn how to successfully market themselves.

“In addition to other individual clients, I also do all of Blue Chip Farms marketing. I'm doing that in my off time. I grew up with riding and showing Arabian horses, which is how I got into horses initially. I have two Arabians and one of my retired trotters who also keep me busy. I ride the Arabians in my spare time, and I also show them too.”

Then there is Zanetti, a horse with undeniable talent, but a penchant for being somewhat unfocused on occasion.

Despite his idiosyncrasies, Del Giudice isn't complaining.

“I think this win meant so much because he has not been an easy horse to get going his whole life. We've had him since he was a baby, we broke him, so of course that makes it special to have developed him over time. He just has a lot of quirks and a big personality, which is a lot of fun in the barn. He likes to play and he's mischievous.

“But he also has his ideas of what he thinks he should be doing on the racetrack and what he likes to look at. He didn't race at two and at three, people would ask, 'Is that the horse whose head is all over the track and he's looking everywhere?' You would literally see him do that on the track. His head would be straight up, and he'd be looking all over the place during the race, not paying attention to what's going on. From day one, we knew he had a lot of talent, so it was just a question of working with that. I don't think we've seen the bottom yet, so the goal is to help him reach his full potential.”

Which is why Del Giudice is happy to be the one to focus on every detail, big or small.

In their newest segment, The Big M added parleys to parlays with some horseman/fan banter prior to the races.

"We appreciate our customers," said Meadowlands' chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemyer. "They are our foundation, and we are trying to use many different ideas and promotions to open our trainers and drivers up to the public so they have more insight into the races and what is going on. It's important that all the trainers and drivers realize that we need to be more open with our customers. Many times, it feels like a hidden society that is plagued with bad news. As you know, Mr. Gural and I stand on integrity and principle, so this is just part of that function."

The Q&A spot kicked off last Saturday's Big M pregame show, with driver Mark MacDonald answering live queries as well as those submitted via Facebook and Twitter.

MacDonald is no stranger to being part of these segments, having recently starred in The Meadowlands' immensely popular "Mark On Mic" series.

"Any time that you can give a little feedback to people that are watching the races – customers or fans – it's good," said MacDonald. "I grew up with five pretty witty brothers, so you've got to be on your tippy toes around everybody anyway."

Meadowlands’ TV talent Edison Hatter and winner’s circle host Gary DiLeo were the perfect tag team, reading online submissions and fielding fan questions, respectively.

Although Hatter doesn’t know yet who the next Q&A horseman will be, he feels anyone asked will handle it well and that the segment will continue to gain in popularity.

“I think it was really good, Mark especially,” said Hatter. “But there is not a single driver at The Meadowlands that I can’t just sit down and talk to for five minutes, be it on camera or not. All those guys are such great professionals.

“The online questions are great, of course. There were a lot of great questions asked. But I really think the in-person ones, on camera, where people get a chance to see themselves and watch the video later, I think that’s really cool too to be able to ask questions in person.”

When it comes to interacting with the fans, no one is better at it than DiLeo. From his post in the winner’s circle, he is in constant communication with the fans.

“I’m there for them and I love to talk to people,” said DiLeo. “It’s good to have the fans get questions answered by the drivers. It’s a one-on-one personal thing and it’s a good thing.”

Although many fans would jump at the chance to ask a question to their favorite horseman, others prefer to remain out of the spotlight.

“Some people are afraid,” said DiLeo. “They say, ‘No I don’t want to go on camera.’ They don’t even want to go in the winner’s circle. Some people say no to that. A lot of these people are just shy.”

Obviously, The Meadowlands team accounted for that bashful possibility by adding in the online option. Not to mention, it allows followers that logistically can’t get to the track a chance to participate.

“The response was good for the first week,” said Settlemoir. “It will continue to build momentum as more people learn about it. I plan on having these each live race night going forward. If

it works and it is beneficial, the segment will be around [after the championship meet].”

As with all live events, there is always the element of unpredictability when you combine a fan with a hot mic.

“It really is a concern with live TV at any time, but most people are respectful and we ask the customer what they are going to ask before going live with the question,” said Settlemoir. “My CCTV team watches and listens closely so they can always close a microphone if they need to or the reporter with the customer can pull the mic away.”

In many ways, that element of not knowing what someone will ask makes the segment fresh and interesting to viewers. Because you don’t know what’s going to come out of people’s mouths, you have to stay tuned.

The Q&A segment is still a work in progress and even though it kicked off the night last week, that doesn’t mean it will on every race card. Depending on what’s happening on a particular night, the spot may take place between the races. Please check Meadowlands’ social media for exactly when it will happen.

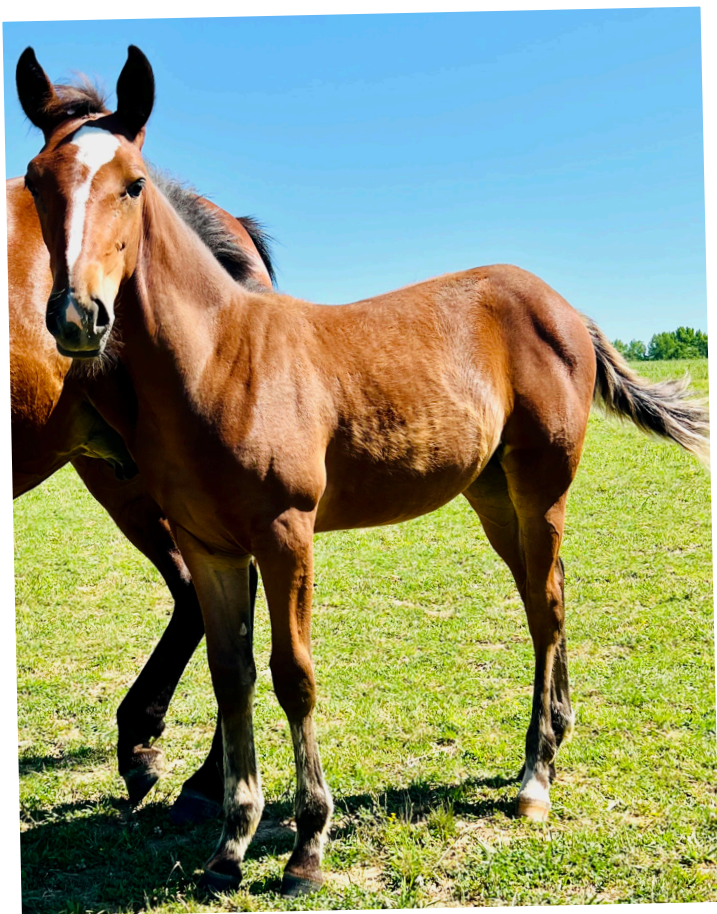

Duval Street fastest in New York Sire Stakes action Tuesday at Yonkers

Two-year-old colt and gelding pacers paid a visit to Yonkers Raceway on Tuesday night (July 5) for three New York Sire Stakes divisions.

In the first \$50,400 split, Johnny Sack (Mark MacDonald) took over the lead from Livonjaxandqueens (Jordan Stratton) after the :27.2 quarter and then would hit the half in :56.2. Johnny Sack withstood a first-over try from Ben Solo (Austin Siegelman) on the way to the 1:26 three-quarters and around the last turn, but driver Brian Sears tipped 4-5 favorite **Duval Street** out three-wide from second-over late on the bend, and Duval Street had the most pace in the lane, rallying by Johnny Sack on his way to a 1 1/2 length decision in 1:54.3. Livonjaxandqueens wound up third.

Duval Street, trained by Nifty Norman, is a Huntsville—Native Bride gelding bred by Sundance Stable LLC. and Jay Sears and

now owned by Sundance Stable LLC. and Kim Sears. Duval Street was making his pari-mutuel debut after winning baby races at Magical Acres and Harrah's Philadelphia. He paid \$3.90 to win and led a \$10.20 exacta and a \$30.40 trifecta.

The second \$50,400 section saw That Dog Will Hunt (Jason Bartlett) blast to the early lead from post four, but Kid Of The Bronx (MacDonald), who went wide on the first turn, drove on and took over the top spot before the :27.4 opening quarter. Kid From The Bronx backed down the half to just :57.4 but then dueled with a first-over **Bandito Joe** (Matt Kakaley) past that marker, with Bandito Joe poking a head in front at the 1:26.2 three-quarters.

Kid From The Bronx battled back gamely on the inside on the last turn and into the lane to regain command, but Bandito Joe kept plugging away on the outside and surged again late in the stretch, and that final thrust was enough to get him by Kid From The Bronx at the wire to prevail by a nose in 1:54.4. That Dog Will Hunt was the third-place finisher.

Travis Alexander trains and co-owns Bandito Joe, a gelded son of Roll With Joe—Blind Faith bred by Mark Powell, with partners Fiddler's Creek Stables LLC., D'Elegance Stable Ix, and T L P Stable. Bandito Joe broke his maiden in his second pari-mutuel attempt, pushed his earnings to \$27,000, and returned \$31.00 to win as a 14-1 offering. The exacta was worth \$214.50 and the trifecta kicked back \$704.

Its A Me Mario (Bartlett) clicked off fractions of 28.1, 58.3, and 1:27.1 in the last \$49,500 flight, but **American Fling** (Scott Zeron) went first-up from third as they raced in the backstretch for the final time and moved into second before three-quarters. Its A

Me Mario managed to keep command around the final turn as American Fling drifted out a bit, but once they straightened up in the lane, American Fling paced by Its A Me Mario and went on to a 1 1/4 length victory in 1:55. Southwind Tito (Siegelman) grabbed third.

The victorious American Ideal gelding is trained by Ed Hart for the ownership group of Randy Bendis, Reed Broadway, and Pollack Racing LLC. American Fling, who was bred by White Birch Farm and brought \$25,000 at last year's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, has a record of 2-1-0 from three starts, and he has now pocketed \$52,375. He paid \$2.70 to win as the 1-5 choice and keyed a \$4.50 exacta and a \$14.60 trifecta.

Heave Ho (by American Ideal, 1:57.1), **Hot Shot Joe** (by Roll With Joe, 1:57.3), and **Human Cocktail** (by Huntsville, 1:56.4) won the three \$15,000 New York Excelsior "A" Series events that took place on the program. David Miller piloted Heave Ho, who was bred by Delaware Valley University, for trainer Sam Schillaci and owners Schillaci Stables LLC. and Sam Bova Racing LLC., Scott Zeron drove Hot Shot Joe, a Crawford Farms-bred, for trainer Todd Luther and owner Black Magic Racing LLC., and Jason Bartlett was in the bike behind Human Cocktail for trainer Gareth Dowse and owner/co-breeder Stephen Demeter.

There was also one \$6,500 New York Excelsior "B" Series tilt, and **Wasn't Me** (by American Ideal) won the non-wagering event in 1:58.1 for driver Jason Bartlett, co-owner/trainer Jim Graham, and co-owners Edward Peron, Timothy Warner, and Paul Tandlmayer. Wasn't Me was bred by White Birch Farm.

In other stakes news from Yonkers, the MGM Springfield Stakes for 2-year-old colt and gelding pacers required no eliminations and will advance straight to the \$98,750 final on Saturday, July 16. The entrants are Francis Raia trainees Married Man and Major Decision, trainer Travis Alexander's Downrightdelicious, Michael Hall pupil Music Hall and Jake Huff student Captain Mikey.

Metro Matty, El Mission Goddess take NYSS wins Wednesday in Buffalo

Metro Matty saved her best for last as she cruised to a solid 2-3/4 length victory over Defiant Lady in the first of two \$51,500 divisions of the New York Sire Stakes for the 2-year-old filly trotters at Buffalo Raceway on Wednesday afternoon (July 6).

In the other bracket, El Mission Goddess let Crazy Lovin do all the dirty work on the front end then popped the pocket in the stretch to grab a 2-1/4 length win in 2:01.4., the same time posted by Metro Matty.

Metro Matty (\$2.80), after tucking in behind the early leader Defiant Lady, fired to the front just before the opening panel

and set splits of :30.3 and 1:02.1 over the fast track.

The back half saw driver Drew Monti step on the gas with Metro Matty as they covered the remaining distance in :59.3 including a :28.4 final quarter. She left Defiant Lady (Kevin Cummings) and Seven Bridges Road (Mark Whitcroft) in her wake and they had to settle for second and third place honors.

Owned by the Bay Pond Racing Stable and trained by John Butenschoen, it was the second win in three starts for Metro Matty (Met's Hall-Order By Matilda). The victory improved her seasonal and career earnings to \$32,250.

El Mission Goddess (\$5.90), after breaking in her lone career start, was on her best behavior this time and took her \$51,500 division.

The favored Crazy Lovin (John Stark Jr.) showed the way with fractions of :30.0, 1:00.2 and 1:32.0 but had El Mission Goddess (Jim Marohn Jr.) drafting along in the pocket.

With the pair in a two-horse breakaway heading into the lane, El Mission Goddess swung to the outside and trotted past Crazy Lovin who could do nothing but watch in vain. Nice Top Line (Kyle Cummings) collected the show spot.

Trained by Tom Corelli, El Mission Goddess (E L Titan-Athena's Mission) notched her first victory in two career tries, pocketing \$25,750 for the victory.

Cross Creek Samara (Brian Cross) is now a perfect 2-for-2 in her brief career with 1-3/4 length score over Jigger Of Gin (Phil Fluet) in the first \$15,000 division of the Excelsior A series. Cross Creek Samara covered the mile in 2:01.2 and returned \$3.30 for the victory.

Crazy Beach (Shawn McDonough) captured the second classification by beating the favored Pat Way (Fluet) by three quarters of a length in 2:03.3. Crazy Beach returned \$10.80 in the mild upset.

In the non-betting \$6,200 Excelsior B contest, **Mets Girl** (Kyle Cummings) got the first place check with a two length triumph over Devious Miss (Joshua Signs).

Justine Irvine and Denny Bucceri each had two victories on the day with Ryan Swift and Gregory Johnson conditioning a pair of winners.

Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots action for rookie pacing fillies got underway Tuesday (July 5) at Woodbine Mohawk Park, and **Bankers Luck** a heavy favorite in the first of five divisions, didn't need any luck to start the evening off with a statement win.

The Tony Alagna trainee was sent off as the 1-9 favorite in the field of nine. Leaving from post two James MacDonald settled her into fifth position early behind fractions of :27.4 and :57.2 set by Ys Bookwriter (Sportswriter).

MacDonald sent the Hes Watching filly first up as the field entered the far turn. She passed the leader in the stretch and paced home in :28 for a two-length score.

"Bankers Luck was terrific," said MacDonald. "I just tried to keep her out of trouble and educate as best I could while still trying to make sure we got the win. She did everything I asked with ease and looks to have a very bright future."

The result was no surprise to the bettors, and Alagna's mom Donna Lee, who trained the filly this winter.

"She's been that type of filly all winter," said Lee. "She trained in Florida and was one of my top three all winter. So, she didn't shock me tonight because I know she had incredible speed."

Bankers Luck was an \$85,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale in October, and she came to Florida from Kentucky ready to work.

"She loved her work and she loved being on the track," said Lee. "We train in sets of eight or nine, and she would have her ears forward, and want to go. She had a great attitude. She never had a bad day."

The filly will target OSS Gold divisions the remainder of the season and is nominated to all the major stakes races at Mohawk. She is owned by Brittany Farms LLC, of Versailles, KY.

In the second and fourth division, Chris Christoforou completed a driving double, beginning with Sweetest **Belle** in race three.

Christoforou maneuvered the Sportswriter filly from post eight into third position by the quarter mile. He moved her first up to the front, taking the lead by the half mile that she never relinquished, fending off a late charge from Momentary Control.

"It was my first time behind Carla Cam, another good-gaited filly that enjoys racing," said Christoforou. "She went a tough trip but was very game. Hopefully, both fillies continue to improve throughout the year."

Carla Cam is owned by Duford, a resident of Leamington, ON.

Race five was the third Grassroots affair and **Favorite Beach** (Sunshine Beach) was the upset winner.

Trevor Henry sat the 8-1 shot off fractions of 28.2 and 58.3 before charging to the front at the half. He would keep her in front, and the Robert MacIntosh trainee held off a late charging Maple (Sportswriter) to win by a neck.

MacIntosh co-owns the homebred with C S X Stables (Liberty Center, OH) and Al McIntosh Holdings Inc (Leamington, Ont.)

The final Grassroots action took place in race nine with Louis-Philippe Roy steering even money favorite **Best Actress**, who he co-owns with Bill Donovan of Delray Beach, FL, to victory.

Roy had his Betterthancheddar filly positioned second as the field entered the stretch, and the Eric Nadeau trainee powered home to score in 1:54.4.



Hammering Hank out of Meadowlands Pace

Trainer Brett Pelling's Hammering Hank will not be behind the starting gate for his Meadowlands Pace elimination Saturday night (July 9). The 3-year-old son of Captaintreacherous—History Repeats has sustained an injury that will keep him on the sidelines for at least several months.

"He has a condylar fracture of the right hind," said Pelling, who was shooting to extend his all-time leading Pace win total to five. "We discovered it late [Wednesday] morning. He trained beautifully but we found some joint inflammation. We had him X-rayed and found the fracture. He's having a screw put in [Thursday] morning. There are actually two types of condylar fractures. Lateral is the bad one. This is on the side of the cannon bone. It's the best one you can have. We'll re-X-ray him in 60 days and determine if he will race again this year, or, if we will wait until next season. That's the game. It's not for the faint of heart."

Hammering Hank had started just two times in 2022, most recently in a Messenger Stakes elimination at Yonkers Raceway.

He finished second to earn a spot in the final, but Pelling kept his prized pupil out of the race. "He warmed up perfect [before the elim] and then he went out onto the track and he wasn't comfortable, so I just decided it wasn't in his best interest to go in the final."

Last year, 'Hank' won eight-of-11 starts, including a victory in the Kindergarten Classic at The Meadowlands on Nov. 13, and banked \$283,218 during his freshman year.

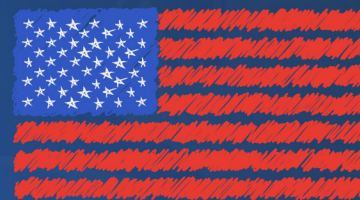

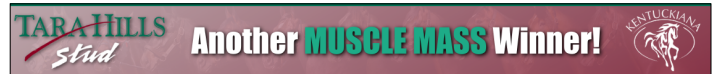

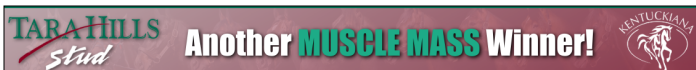
