# Virtual Reality could be the key to the ultimate yearling video

Veteran yearling videographer Aaron Re believes VR could be a huge benefit to farms during the COVID-19 era when fewer people are expected to be able to inspect horses in person.

Videographer Aaron Re of Hanover, PA believes producing yearling videos using Virtual Reality (VR) technology could be a boon for farms selling horses in the COVID-19 era when in-person farm inspections may be more difficult.


"I've been pushing this for four years because I really see the number of people coming to farms gets less and less every year and especially some of these smaller farms that have a half dozen yearlings, people aren't going to drive out of their way to go to see them. But, with the recent (COVID-19) events, I feel that it's even more relevant now than ever," Re said.

VR uses special cameras and technology to produce an immersive three-dimensional (3D) experience when the video is viewed with a special headset.

"In a nutshell, it's just almost like being there, like the horse is literally standing right in front of you, so you get a

much better feel of the size and a better look at the conformation than just looking at a screen," Re said. "Until you try it, you don't really get the 'wow factor' so it's a hard thing to explain to people.

"You have to use a special 360-degree camera, which I have. The video can still be viewed in a traditional manner on a flat screen on YouTube, but the camera captures your entire field of view so it give you the ability – if you're wearing a head-mounted display – to move your head around. If you want to look at the legs, you can look at the legs. If you want to look at the head, you stare at the head.

"If you watch a (traditional) video on even a 40-inch screen, the horse is still smaller than the horse is in real life. When you put on the headsets, it's the exact size. It's like you're standing there and that's what people need to grasp."

Re, who has been producing yearlings videos for 25 years, among other corporate video work, estimates his cost for producing a video in VR is around 20 per cent more than doing a traditional video.

"I think I've always been a fair guy in the business, charging a fair price. The added cost for the VR would be minimal, maybe 20 per cent difference over the regular video. It's not double the price," he said. "It's just something that I'm looking to do to help out my good clients. I feel like it would be a real advantage to buyers that may not want to come to the farm."

Re said he understands there's a steep learning curve for those that have never used VR and don't own a headset — especially since standardbred buyers tend to skew older — but he believes this is a good year for people to at least try the technology, which can cost as little as \$5.

"I plan on producing some training videos before the end of July to make people aware of what is coming and how to use it, what they need to buy... and these headsets can be as cheap as \$5. The higher quality one that I recommend is \$150, so it's a small investment. I feel like once people see it, they are going to say, 'I need this."

The learning curve is the problem videographer Curtis MacDonald of Ontario-based Cujo Entertainment sees with VR gaining widespread adoption in the yearling market. He said he looked into the technology because he was approached about possibly producing VR videos of stallions.

"I thought, 'How many people are going to actually do this?' It's one thing to have VR available, but....let's say there's 10,000 people that attend sales, how many of those 10,000 would go out and buy a VR headset? Or would it be something the breeding farms would send you, like, send out an inexpensive VR headset that you slide your phone into," MacDonald said. "That might be something, but, then again, how many of those 10,000 are actually going to take it out of the box and go through the steps and set it up?



Though one needs a VR headset to get the full immersive experience of a VR video, Re said the options range from an inexpensive \$5 viewer to a \$150 set.

"It's a good idea, I just don't know how many people would actually use it."

Re said he hasn't produced any VR yearling videos for clients, yet, part because some farms were hesitant to, "give people another reason not to come" to the farm. But, in the midst of a pandemic, some people may not feel comfortable coming.

"For the big farms, I understand their hesitation in years past, but I really feel like some of these smaller farms could greatly benefit from it."

MacDonald said even if VR technology achieved widespread adoption, it still likely wouldn't replace the value of seeing horses in person.


"If you're planning on spending several hundred thousand dollars at a sale, chances are you're still going to go to the farm and have a look at the horse," MacDonald said. "I don't think you'll get too many wanting to spend hundreds of thousands of dollars on a horse that they haven't physically seen.

"But, you know, it's all those other horses that make up the sale that people aren't spending hundreds of thousands of dollars on the horse and they don't go to the farm to see it and maybe they don't even go to the sale anymore and see it. They just look at it, whether it's on a regular video or a VR video. Those other horses that aren't the sale toppers, they get sold, too, and people want to see all of the footage on them."

### **NOT A NEW TECHNOLOGY**

Re said he's been interested in Virtual Reality technology ever since he got his first headset around 1991.

"Even though it's more widespread now, it still has that 'you've got to be a techie' feel about it. It's not something



that an everyday guy can just put on, but I feel like when I do these training videos that it's going to put people more at ease to try it," Re said, adding VR technology is also improving dramatically.

"I'd say within two years, the headsets that are close to the resolution of our eyes are coming. Right now, I would say, they are 10 times better than they were three years ago, but it's still not as crystal clear as if you were right there," he said. "In two years, the headsets are going to be there where it's like you won't tell it apart from real life."

VR also could have applications in the horse racing business beyond yearlings.

MacDonald said he's tested the technology during races by putting a camera on drivers' helmets or sulkies.

"I did it last year for a couple of races. We did it with (my brother) James (MacDonald) in the Battle of Waterloo elimination... It was a 360-degree camera so you saw him wherever he was."

MacDonald said he sees the day when a number of drivers are wearing VR cameras and viewers could watch the race from a huge number of up-close angles.

"That day may not be that far off. Technology is advancing rapidly," MacDonald said.

Re agreed that VR would be a terrific way to present harness racing.

"It's a great technology for the races and I've seen that the thoroughbred people have really done it right and the standardbreds have taken a crack at it a couple of years ago and they just don't have the right mix of equipment to get that set up," Re said. "I really picture people watching the races wearing a headset and riding along with whichever horse that they want to follow and it's a phenomenal view of the race."

Best known in the gaming world, VR also has the ability to give viewers an immersive experience with far-away places — another benefit during a pandemic with travel restricted.

"If you look at tourism, with VR you can look at Egypt and it's like you're standing right there. It's phenomenal," Re said.

He can well imagine how the technology could allow a horse buyer to sit at home and do a thorough virtual inspection of horses from around the world.



### American Courage dominates \$104,250 MGM Springfield at Yonkers

The rookie American Ideal colt is now undefeated in three career starts for trainer Travis Alexander.

American Courage made a decisive brush to the lead approaching the first quarter and held off the pocket-sitting Town Gossip to prevail Monday (July 13) at Yonkers in the

\$104,250 MGM Springfield Stakes by a half-length in 1:53.3.

American Courage remains unbeaten in four lifetime starts for trainer Travis Alexander, driver Matt Kakaley and owner Fiddler's Creek Stables of West Bloomfield, MI (Alaina Alexander, Leslie Waserman and Mark Waserman).

The 2-year-old homebred colt by American Ideal is the first foal out of the Art Major mare Nota Fool Bluechip.

The heavy favorite in the race, American Courage paid \$2.40 to win. Crystal Beach was six and three quarter lengths back in third.

The MGM Springfield is the new name for the Lawrence B. Sheppard Pace. MGM Resorts, which purchased the New York racetrack and casino in January of 2019, renamed a number of Yonkers' stakes races in honor of other MGM properties. MGM Springfield is a casino located in Springfield, MA.

### Wilder ready to 'Fire' in first Meadowlands Pace

Mike Wilder has driven in more than 55,000 races in his 30-year career, but never in the final of a Meadowlands Pace. That, however, will change this weekend. Wilder makes his first trip to The Meadowlands Racetrack for its signature event Saturday, when he will sit behind Catch The Fire in the \$631,650 race for 3-year-old male pacers.

"It's nice to be a part of that," said Wilder, who has won 8,276 races while competing mostly in Ohio and Pennsylvania. "It's not like every year you know you're going to be in a certain race. Obviously, I've been driving 30 years and it's my first time, so it takes a good horse. It takes a good horse and being at the right place at the right time.

"Catch The Fire has been a really good horse. He's pretty special."

Of the Meadowlands Pace final's 10 drivers, Wilder is the only one making his first appearance. The last driver to win the Pace in his first try was Tim Tetrick with Southwind Lynx in 2007.

Catch The Fire heads to the Meadowlands Pace final off a seventh-place finish in last week's single elimination. The

colt started from post eight, was last in the 10-horse field at the half, and rallied with a :25.4 last quarter-mile to grab a spot in the final.

He starts Saturday from post two and is 10-1 on the morning line. Elimination winner Tall Dark Stranger is the 7-5 favorite.

"The (elimination) was kind of tough the way the race shook out," Wilder said. "That being said, he raced terrific. That horse, he just shows up. Even the other night, he was seventh, but he showed up. He had to pace :25.4 to get the job done and he did it.

"I was very happy to see where he drew in the final, it gives him a chance to be part of the fight. Hopefully things shake out good and we get the right trip and get some money. It would be nice to win the race, everybody wants to win, but I don't think there is any question he could be able to grab some of the prize money."

Catch The Fire was purchased for \$15,000 at the 2018 Lexington Selected Sale. He is owned by Charles Taylor's CT Stables and trained by John Ackley. The horse's sire,



Captaintreacherous, won the 2013 Meadowlands Pace. His dam, Dream Outloud, is a half-sister to Life's litreasure, who produced 2016 Meadowlands Pace winner Control The Moment.

Wilder has driven Catch The Fire in all but one of the colt's 14 career starts. Last year, Catch The Fire won the Kentucky Sire Stakes championship and was third in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes final. He has won four of 14 races lifetime, hit the board a total of 10 times, and earned \$260,047.

"He was pretty special last year," Wilder said. "The first time I raced him, he's not a real big horse at all but John told me not to worry about the size of the horse, he's a very nice colt. That particular day, he was second in the (Pennsylvania) sire stakes at The Meadows. He paced home in :26.3 and you don't get many horses that can do that, especially a 2-year-old. I knew then that I had my hands on something pretty nice."

Wilder is an Ohio native and won 13 driving titles at Lebanon and two at Scioto Downs before moving to The Meadows in western Pennsylvania in 2001. Over the past 10 years, he has annually ranked among the top-five drivers at The Meadows in wins and purses. Five times in the past six years he has finished second to perennial Meadows driving champ Dave Palone in wins.

This season, Wilder leads drivers at The Meadows in purses with \$1.1 million and is second to Palone in wins with 126. Overall, Wilder has won 142 races this year, ninth best in North America.

Catch The Fire could keep Wilder on the road for a number of Grand Circuit races. The colt is staked to the North America Cup, Breeders Crown, Little Brown Jug, Cane Pace, Messenger Pace, Tattersalls Pace, and Matron Stakes, as well as the Delvin Miller Adios at Wilder's home track.

"You hope the horse stays healthy and sound and wherever they choose to race him I'm sure he is going to fight," Wilder said. "With the right trip, he's always going to kick home for you, he's always digging. That's how you get paid. This horse can get to the (first) quarter in :26 and then he comes home in :26. I think that's what it takes to be a horse at that level and I think he's proven himself to be that kind of horse.

"I'm really looking forward to the season with him and I'm really looking forward to Saturday night being in the Meadowlands Pace."

The Meadowlands Pace is part of a jam-packed stakes slate Saturday at the Big M. The card also includes the Hambletonian Maturity for 4-year-old trotters, William R. Haughton Memorial for older male pacers, Dorothy Haughton

Memorial for older female pacers, Stanley Dancer Memorial for 3-year-old male trotters, Del Miller Memorial for 3-year-old female trotters, Mistletoe Shalee for 3-year-old female pacers, and the third leg of the Miss Versatility Series for older female trotters.

### You Make The Call - feedback

In our July 12 issue (**full story here**), we asked you to make the call on a race at Yonkers on July 7 (**replay available here**).

Here's some of your feedback:

4 should have stayed 3rd.

—Caesar Fiorini

I don't have a problem with the judges call. The horse was on a break for most of the stretch and he wasn't restrained much.

—Don Neuwirth

I wouldn't have placed anyone. There wasn't any interference and every horse that made breaks lost ground.

—Donald Pfister

Correct Call. Placed last for failure to attempt to get the breaking horse back on gate. The driver let him run the last 16th of a mile.

—Jeffrey Feinman

I see no reason for that placing. The 3 made breaks and lost ground while on a break and create no interference while on a break that I saw.

—John Vance

I believe Limitless Winner should have remained 3rd. The driver of Limitless Winner grabs into him to try to get him back on gait. At least it looks that way to me. I see no reason to place him behind the other two who made earlier breaks.

### —Darren Henry

I do not understand why Limitless Winner was placed. No interference and he did lose ground while on the gallop. Crossing the line in a break is not reason enough to place him. If it were, there wouldn't be a rule about being lapped on.

### —David Glasser

Guessing the judges invoked the "Extended Break" rule. I understand the importance of the rule, but I believe an slight tweak should be made. The driver did everything in his power to follow the breaking rule but since the horse ran over "25" strides he "can be" set to last. If the horse runs with the field and loses just a length or two and comes back behind the pack, understandable placing. But the other horses never had a chance in catching.

### Fruit-loving filly captures Gold Series opener at Georgian Downs

Mark Etsell's 2-year-old trotting fillies opened their Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) careers on a positive note Sunday night (July 12) at Georgian Downs with **Midnight Miracle** scoring a win in her \$72,267 Gold Series division and Meadowview Lilly finishing third.

Midnight Miracle got a picture-perfect second-over trip from driver Bob McClure in the evening's first Gold Series battle. Starting from Post 2 McClure settled the Muscle Mass daughter in fourth and watched Tealicious ring up a :26 quarter and :58.2 half. Heading for the 1:29.1 three-quarters McClure tipped Midnight Miracle out behind Dashing Muscle, who was soon matching strides with the tiring pacesetter. When McClure asked for another gear in the stretch, Midnight Miracle powered by her peers and on to a one and one-quarter length victory in 1:58.4.

"I told Bobby to float her out of there and try to get away, top three I said, but he got four so that's okay. I said, 'Once she sees daylight she can kind of trot, but as soon as she doesn't see them she'll let up on you, so just be aware of that'. You time it kind of right, because she's green and she doesn't know any different. She knows enough to go by and then that's it and then she'll let up," said Etsell. "First lifetime start so we were pretty happy with her, at least I was anyways, I don't know about anybody else, but I was."

Named Midnight Miracle due to a difficult birth, the filly has grown into a good-gaited, sensible filly who might just be a little spoiled by Etsell and his partners Robert Newton of Walkerton and Chuan Tan of Cambridge, ON.

"She loves watermelon; she had a watermelon after she raced tonight and got out of the test barn. She loves watermelon and raspberries for some reason, I don't know why," said Etsell. "Bob Newton, when he comes down he brings her raspberries or something, stops at one of the

grocery stores along the way."

Two races later, Meadowview Lilly delivered a third-place finish behind fan favorite **Fox Valley Liza** and Blackout Riley, a result that delighted Etsell and Charlie Reid, whose Meadowview Farms Inc. of Orono, ON, bred and owns the Archangel daughter.

"She was good early, good gaited and everything, but didn't have the attitude to go, but when we hit around 2:20 she started coming to life and we thought, you know maybe we've got a couple," said Etsell, who also drove Meadowview Lilly on Sunday. "We were happy with both of the fillies. Both are homebreds. I raced both their mothers."

Sent off as the heavy favorite in the second \$72,267 division, Fox Valley Liza and driver Sylvain Filion wasted no time assuring bettors they had made the correct choice. Starting from Post 6 the pair carved out all the fractions on their way to a three length victory in 1:59.2.

"She's just come to me 10 days ago. She's exactly everything that Erv Miller told me — she's very professional, a very nice filly to be around and she won pretty handy," said trainer Ben Baillargeon, who received the Muscle Mass daughter from U.S.-based trainer Ervin Miller after she finished second in a two-year-old filly event at Pocono Downs on June 30. "She knows her business and Erv said she's been professional from Day 1. She's like a four-year-old horse, like a very nice mare."

Anthony Lombardi of Morris, IL, Henshaut Stable of Montgomery, IN and George Golemes of Oak Brook, IL share ownership of Fox Valley Liza, who Baillargeon expects will remain in the province for the duration of the Ontario Sires Stakes season.

The last division went to **Classy Carol** who sprinted from sixth to first in the stretch, sneaking up the inside past pacesetting favorite Warrawee Welcome to claim the 2:01.1 victory. Flanagan Destiny and All R Wishes finished just over one length back in second and third.

"She's my daughter Robyn's favorite horse. She's spoiled and she's good natured, good to be around, and turns out she wants to win, so that's even better," said trainer John Bax. "She wants to go ahead, and you can't teach that, they've either got it or they don't, so it's nice."

The Bax Stable of Campbellville, Robert Van Camp of Port Perry, ON, Dave Hudson of Dallas, TX and Gordon Wright of Charlotte, MI share ownership of Classy Carol, who was a \$40,000 purchase from the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale. Bax trained both the Royalty For Life daughter's dam Very Classy and her grand-dam Ruling Class.

Like Etsell, Bax had multiple fillies competing on Sunday and was pleased with the results of all three. In addition to Classy Carol's win, Kadabra daughter Up And Ready finished third to Midnight Miracle and Royalty For Life miss Lifeintheslammer was fifth behind Fox Valley Liza.

"We were pretty happy with them," said the Campbellville, ON resident. "They all did it right. Some have got to do it a little faster, but they all took positive steps ahead, that's for sure."

The 2-year-old trotting fillies will make their second Gold Series start at Woodbine Mohawk Park on July 31.

Next up on Georgian Downs' Ontario Sires Stakes schedule is the second Gold Series Leg for 2-year-old pacing fillies on Sunday, July 19.

As they made the turn for home the only one with a shot was second-place finisher, Alleyesonme AS but she couldn't get close and Hen Party breezed home in a lifetime best time of 1:52.0. Rapunzel Bluechip (Jason Bartlett) finished a distant third.

Hen Party is a 3-year-old filly by Roll With Joe. Owned by Crawford Farms Racing and trained by Tony Alagna, she won for the second time this season. She has five career victories.

**Merga Hanover** (Matt Kakaley) charged late to win the second division of the NYSS.

Racine Bell (Jason Bartlett) flew out of the gate and went straight to the lead. She hit the first quarter in :27. The filly went :28.4 in the second quarter to hit the half first in :55.4. As they reached the backstretch So Rude (Joe Bongiorno) came first up and put on the pressure. Racine Bell held on to

a slight lead as they hit three-quarters in 1:22.1.

So Rude wrestled the lead away as they reached the stretch. Merga Hanover (\$41.20) popped out of the pocket going three-wide in mid-stretch and blew right on by to win in a lifetime best of 1:51.1. So Rude held for second with Dragon Roll (Jim Morrill Jr.) coming up to get third.

Other colt winners included: **Illini Duke**, by Well Said, in 1:56.3 for Chris Page and owner-trainer Brian Roebuck; **He's A Dickens**, by Well Said, in 1:55.2 for Tyler Smith, Kris Hinchcliff and owner Elliot Misshula; **KB Mac**, by McArdle, in 1:55.3 for Ryan Stahl, Dan Venier and owners Ken and John Saunders; **Weekend Pass**, by Big Bad John, in 1:55.2 for Dan and Christi Noble for owners Brent Hopper, Kyle Gray and Jerry Scheve.

The fillies were led by **Apple Soozy** with Andy Shetler for

trainer Dan O'Mara and owner Marjorie Polhamus in 1:55.1. The Mr Apples filly is a perfect three-for-three after the two-hole trip before winning by 1-3/4 lengths. Another winner for the driver, trainer and owner combination was **Rainy Day Chic**, by Rockin Amadeus, in 1:55.3 going wire to wire winning by <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> lengths. She is now two-for-three lifetime.

**Smothastenesewisky** is now two-for-two in lifetime starts with the win in 1:54.3 with Chris Page. Brian Haynes owns and trains the Nob Hill High daughter, who got away fifth and took command before the half, drawing away by 6 1/4 lengths.

The fastest of the six divisions for the fillies was **Heavenissofaraway** who came home the winner in 1:54.1 with Chris Page for owner-trainer Anette Lorentzon. The daughter of Racing Hill went coast to coast winning by 2 ½ lengths.

# Novice fillies show off pro-level skills in Grassroots debut

A quartet of \$23,000 Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots divisions for 2-year-old trotting fillies was featured at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Monday, July 13 and all four

winners delivered the kind of professional performance typically seen in far older horses.

You Will Be Queen took the opening division with a 1:59 effort that saw her leave well from Post 5, occupy the front end briefly before letting two rivals go around, and then step back out in the stretch and sprint home to a three and one-quarter length victory. Fan favorite A Blue Blood settled for second and Darling Please finished third.

"You couldn't ask for better. She left to the front and let one go, let a couple go, and come back out and come wide and win easy," said trainer Dustin Jones of the trip engineered by driver Chris Christoforou. "What you saw on the track tonight was about how she trained all winter. If she made a break it was just because she wasn't paying attention or something like that."

Jones bred and owns You Will Be Queen in partnership with Hebert Horses Inc. of Montreal, QC. The partners raced the filly's dam, Dewdle All Day, who earned \$382,000 racing in the same Ontario Sires Stakes class as million dollar earners Emoticon Hanover and Caprice Hill.

"She raced against Emoticon Hanover and all them good fillies and still ended up making almost \$400,000, so she was a pretty good mare," said Jones, noting that Royalty For Life daughter You Will Be Queen is the mare's first foal. "This filly, she's been good all along. We probably could have went to the Gold, but we wanted to race her on the big track to start."

In the second \$23,500 division fan favorite **Imextraspecial** had to circle out three wide heading for the three-quarters to find her way to the lead, and still powered home to a one and one-half length victory in 2:01.1. Jones and Can You Swing It finished second and Top Of The Bar was third.

Paul Walker trains and drives Imextraspecial for Keith Coulter of Mono, ON, who offered up \$95,000 for the Muscle Mass daughter at last fall's London Selected Yearling Sale.

Less than one week after her arrival in Ontario, **Ban Ban Deo** took the third division, getting a confident steer from Sylvain Filion who sent the favorite to the lead heading for the half and let her cruise home to a three-quarter length victory in 1:59.1. Tipsy In Dixie finished second and Snowfalla completed the top three.

Owned by John Fielding and Clay Horner of Toronto, ON, Ban Ban Deo learned her early lessons in the Richard "Nifty" Norman stable and will spend the Ontario Sires Stakes season in the barn of Tony O'Sullivan, who said she has been flawless since her arrival.

"She's completely professional. The first time I took her out

on the track at Classy (Lane) nothing seemed to faze her, at Mohawk here tonight nothing fazed her whatsoever. She's smart," said O' Sullivan of the Kadabra daughter. "She's a decent sized filly; she's got a lot of leg, she's long. You could actually see she's a little bit bigger than what she raced against tonight, and I think that factored into the decision to put her in the Grassroots, just to let her come along at her own speed. But she's a beautiful filly and I would imagine, as long as everything goes well, I think by the end of the year she'll be a big strong filly, she'll fill into herself."

Charmbo Princess also got a confident steer from Mike Saftic, who left smarty with the filly from Post 2 and then pointed her back toward the front heading by the three-quarters. Charmbo Princess kicked home smartly to post a one and one-quarter length victory in 2:00. Fortune Tellers K finished second and Mag N Lady was third.

"She is a very nice filly. Her mother was a very professional mare and this mare just takes the bit and says, 'Let's go!' And apparently she did everything right tonight," said Randy Rier, who bred and owns the daughter of Royalty For Life and Hetties Charm in partnership with his brother Jack Rier of Kitchener, ON.

"I was surprised when he moved her the first time, and then he got out, I thought, early enough and I thought oh well, I guess he knows what he's doing. And then he tried to pull the ear plugs and they wouldn't come out and I said to him later, I said, 'That's okay, because she runs right in when they pop," added the Hanover, ON resident with a chuckle. "But they never got out so it's good. He said she went right on by herself anyway."

The highly capable 2-year-old trotting fillies will make their second Grassroots start at Grand River Raceway on July 29.

# Record breaking online sale at Menhammar in Sweden

Twenty-six horses from Sweden's Menhammar and four horses from Annemanna were sold for record prices at Menhammar OnlineSales 2020 live-streamed auction. The price average was 556,500 SEK (over \$61,000 U.S.), which is the highest ever recorded in Europe.

"Right now I am just truly happy. We have been working in haste to create something completely novel, and it turned out to be a success in the end," said Menhammar's Margareta Wallenius-Kleberg.

The whole concept behind Menhammar OnlineSales was created during the spring and early summer to fulfill the need for an auction despite the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. The live-streamed online auction came to an end late Sunday night (July 12) with amazing results, which all can be found at the auction website: menhammaronlinesales.se.

The third horse to enter the auction ring, Eireann (Maharajah – Darling Boko–Chocolatier) from Annemanna, became the first of five horses who were sold for over one million SEK (about \$110,000 U.S.). The most expensive was #29 East Ward (Maharajah–Way Out West–Chapter Seven), who was sold for 1,800,000 SEK (about \$200,000 U.S.) to Lennart Ågren (SRF Stables).

"This whole livestreamed online auction concept was developed at short notice and that is why it was especially satisfying to succeed in this way. The prices were fantastic, the whole concept worked as it was supposed to and we all have learned something new from this experience. I don't think this was the last we saw of the whole online auction concept," said DVM and general manager Johan Hellander.

The Median price for the sold horses was 400,000 SEK (\$44,000 U.S.) and the average price was record-high, 556 000 SEK (over \$61,000 U.S.). Annemanna sold four horses of which two, Escada (1 175 000) and Eireann (1 250 000), were sold for more than one million SEK."

"The best part of the night was to see the joy in my mother Margareta's eyes. The fact that we had the courage to try something new and succeed in this way feels truly fantastic. I hope that both the bidders and also the vast online audience we had share this feeling, says Annika Bootsman Kleberg.

Trainers Ron Burke and Nancy Takter each accounted for two \$30,000 divisions of a Pennsylvania All-Stars event for 2-year-old pacing colts during a Sunday twilight card at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, with Burke sending out the fastest two winners and Takter harnessing victorious sons of Always B Miki.

**Fulsome**, a colt by Betting Line-Triple V Hanover, was much better in his second purse start to break his maiden and win the fastest of the five All-Stars sections. Moved to the lead in the second quarter by driver Yannick Gingras, the pair came their last split in :27.3 to post a 1:52.2 victory, two lengths clear of Capt Jack Hanover. William Donovan, Thomas Dillon, Purnel & Libby, and Joe Sbrocco co-own the Burke trainee.

The Brigade sent out the 1-2 finishers in the first All-Stars race, as the Sweet Lou–Lucy's Pearl colt **Lou's Pearlman** followed the cover of fellow 6-5 shot and stablemate Summa Cum Laude late on the backstretch, then finished out his own back half in :54.4 - :27.1 to defeat his barn-mate by a half-length in a career best 1:52.4. A winner in the first prelim of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes as well, Lou's Pearlman was driven by Joe Bongiorno in his All-Stars triumph for Burke Racing Stable LLC and Weaver Bruscemi LLC, Elizabeth Novak, and Howard Taylor.

The Takter-trained **Always A Miki** squared off against fellow PA Sires winner Bayfield Beach in his division, but after Always A Miki got away with a :57.4 half, there was no catching him in the :55.3 - :27.2 back fractions, completing this mile in 1:53.2 after winning his Sires event a full second faster. The Always B Miki-Beach Gal colt defeated Bayfield Beach by 1¾ lengths; mention should also be mentioned of 59-1 shot Whole Lotta Lou, who came uncovered from seventh and held for third. Dexter Dunn had sulky duty behind the winner for owners Christina Takter, Goran Anderberg, Herb Liverman, and the Rojan Stables.

The Always B Miki – Katie Said colt **Monterey Jack** made his purse debut a winning one for Takter, getting a :58.3 half after forcing a lineup from the rail, then jetting home in :55.3 - :27.2 for a new mark of 1:54.1, 334 lengths ahead of

Batterup Hanover. Yannick Gingras, getting a Sire Stakes victory for both doubling trainers, drove "Jack" to the easy win for Black Horse Racing, Caviart Farms, and John Fielding.

In the other All-Stars event, the Captaintreacherous—Calgary Hanover gelding Chase H Hanover also used the rail to force an early lineup, then sprinted home in :55.1 - :27.1 to take a mark of 1:53.2, 1¾ lengths ahead of Straight Talk. Scott Cox conditions the David Miller-driven winner for himself and co-owner Jason Ash.

The 2-year-olds have come to establish their form quickly in Pennsylvania – all five winners were sent off as the post-time betting favorite.
